CM Revanth Reddy's Key Orders to DGP

Chief Minister's directives on maintaining peace and security. CM urges strict action against anyone disturbing peace and order. Accusations that BRS is attempting to damage Hyderabad's brand image.

TPN, Telangana: Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has issued key orders to Telangana DGP Jitender regarding law and order in the state. The CM instructed that anyone who disrupts peace and security should be dealt with severely. He emphasized that political conspiracies aimed at tarnishing the brand image of Telangana and Hyderabad will not be tolerated under any circumstances. He accused the opposition BRS of working to damage Hyderabad's reputation.

We Have KCR's Lucky Number

During his visit to Delhi yesterday, CM Revanth Reddy remarked that BRS and BJP leaders have repeatedly claimed they would topple the government. However, he confidently stated that their government remains secure because they have "KCR's lucky number." He clarified that the final decision regarding the defection of MLAs rests with the Speaker and assured that the matter will be handled in accordance with the Constitution.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The number of Vande Bharat trains operating between Andhra Pradesh and Telangana is set to increase. The central government recently announced more good news for the people of the Telugu states. As part of the Vinayaka Chavithi Navratri celebrations, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will launch two new Vande Bharat trains on September 16.

KCR Should Respond to Kaushik Reddy's Comments About Me

- Gandhi says he came to Hyderabad just like Kaushik Reddy.
- Accuses Kaushik Reddy of being a "cheater and broker."
- Questions why BRS gave PAC post to someone like Kaushik Reddy.

TPN, Telangana: Serilingampally MLA Arekapudi Gandhi has demanded that KCR respond to BRS MLA Kaushik Reddy's comments, where he labeled Gandhi as an "Andhra" person. Gandhi pointed out that he, too, came to Hyderabad to live, just as Kaushik Reddy did.



Gandhi alleged that Kaushik Reddy has cheated many people and compared himself to Reddy, saying both came to Hyderabad for similar reasons. He further stated that it was Harish Rao who brought him into the BRS party and reaffirmed his position as a BRS member, emphasizing that even the Speaker of the Assembly has acknowledged his role within the party.

Gandhi expressed his disappointment, accusing Kaushik Reddy of damaging the BRS party, calling him a "cheater and broker." He said that he was forced to react because Kaushik Reddy's comments hurt his sentiments and provoked him repeatedly. Gandhi likened his reaction to that of a cornered animal, saying, "If a cat is locked in a room and beaten, it will eventually strike back."

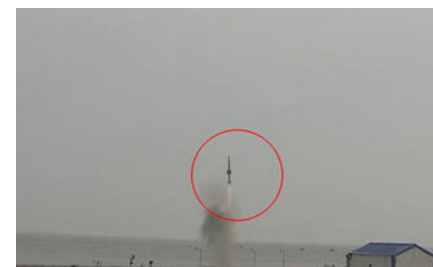
He recalled KCR's previous statement

that if settlers faced any issues, he would "remove the thorn with his tooth." Gandhi also questioned why the BRS party had given the PAC post to someone like Kaushik Reddy, asking why Akbaruddin Owaisi was chosen over a Congress leader for the role.

Meanwhile, in light of the call by BRS leaders for a rally to Gandhi's residence, a large police force has been deployed around his house to maintain peace.

India Successfully Test Fires Two Surface-to-air Missiles in Two Days

TPN, Odisha: India successfully test-fired the Vertical Launch Short Range Surface to Air Missile (VLSRSAM) for the second consecutive day from the Integrated Test Range (ITR) at Chandipur on the Odisha coast, defence sources said on Friday.



A statement from the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) confirmed that the tests, conducted on September 12 and 13, were successful.

"In both the tests, the missile successfully intercepted a high-speed low-altitude aerial target mimicking a sea-skimming aerial threat," the statement said. The missile demonstrated its precision and capability to neutralize targets effectively.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh

praised DRDO, the Indian Navy, and all associated teams for the successful flight tests. He noted that this missile, equipped with modern technologies, would give a further technological boost to the Armed Forces. For safety reasons, the Balasore district administration temporarily relocated 3,100 residents from six villages within a 2.5 km radius of ITR Launch Pad 3. A revenue official stated that these precautions were taken in consultation with ITR authorities.

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Hydra's Real Intention is to Divert Investments to Amaravati

TPN, Telangana: BRS legislator Padi Kaushik Reddy once again criticized the Revanth Reddy-led government, accusing it of conspiring to divert investments to Amaravati under the direction of former Andhra Pradesh CM Chandrababu Naidu. He addressed these issues following BRS's "Chalo Arikepudi Gandhi's Residence" call.

Speaking at a press conference held at the residence of Medchal District BRS President and MLC Shambhipur Raju,

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TPN, Telangana: The political battle between Padi Kaushik Reddy, a legislator from the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS), and Arikepudi Gandhi, a fellow party MLA who recently joined the Congress, has escalated significantly, resulting in mass house arrests. Several BRS leaders across Telangana, including in Hyderabad, were placed under house arrest, though restrictions were later lifted.

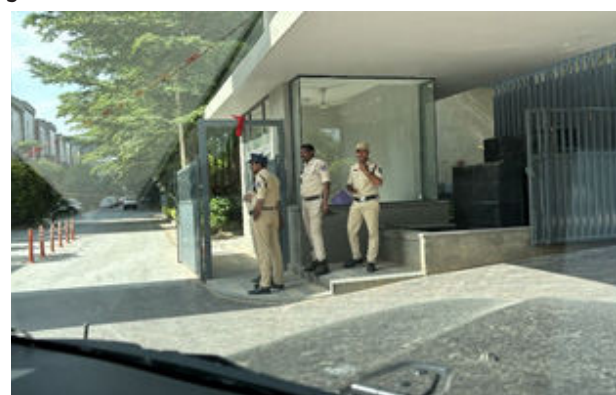
Kaushik Reddy has been vocally critical of MLAs from his own party who switched to the ruling Congress under Chief Minister Revanth Reddy. He ridiculed their defection,

sending them sarees and glasses, sarcastically questioning their honor. Reddy even expressed a desire to visit constituencies where these gifts were not accepted, further stoking tensions.

Kaushik Reddy's harsh comments targeted several defected MLAs, including Kadiyam Srihari (Station Ghanpur), Daman Nagender (Khairatabad), Tellam Venkatarao (Bhadrachalam), Pocharam Srinivasa Reddy (Bansuwada), Dr. M Sanjay Kumar (Jagityala), Kale Yadaya (Chevella), Bandla Krishnamohan Reddy (Gadwal), T Prakash Goud

(Rajendranagar), Arikepudi Gandhi (Serilingampally), and Gudem Mahipal Reddy (Patancheru). Kaushik Reddy demanded the immediate disqualification of these MLAs, handing over a petition to implement the High Court's judgment on the matter. He referred to Kadiyam Srihari as a "swindler" and Dana Nagender as a "beggar," accusing them of repeated party defections.

Senior BRS leader and former minister Tanniru Harish Rao supported Kaushik Reddy, protesting against the police for registering a case against him at the Hyderabad City Police Commissioner's Office in



Basheer Bagh.

In response, BRS called for a "Chalo Gandhi's Residence" rally, with Medchal district president and MLC Shambhipur Raju leading the call.

The rally was planned to start at 11 a.m. from Raju's residence in Mallampet and proceed to Arikepudi Gandhi's residence.

Amid these escalating tensions, the police implemented precautionary measures. BRS leaders, including Harish Rao, were placed under house arrest, and a large police force was deployed at their residences.

These developments have led to a tense atmosphere in many districts, including Hyderabad.

Hydra's Real Intention is to Divert Investments to Amaravati

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Kaushik Reddy clarified that his disagreement with Arikepudi Gandhi was a personal matter and had nothing to do with the Andhra settlers in Telangana. He reiterated his respect for the Andhra settlers living in Telangana, including Hyderabad, and reminded everyone of KCR's earlier statement that if a thorn were to prick the foot of an Andhra person, he would remove it with his teeth. He noted that during KCR's 10-year rule, there was not a single incident of discrimination against Andhras.

Kaushik Reddy criticized Congress leaders for stirring up divisive politics in the name of Andhra-Telangana differences. He further accused the Revanth Reddy government of using the Hydra initiative to demolish buildings, causing unnecessary trouble for Hyderabad residents. He claimed that these actions are damaging the city's brand image and discouraging investment.

Kaushik Reddy alleged that the government's actions are part of a conspiracy to block Hyderabad's development and divert investments to Amaravati, following directions from Chandrababu Naidu. He urged the people of Telangana to remain vigilant and recognize the harmful intent behind these moves, emphasizing that during the BRS's decade-long governance, Hyderabad became a welcoming city for all, including people from Andhra and other states, and rose to become the number one city in the country.

Two New Vande Bharat Trains for Telugu States

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The two new trains will run between Nagpur-Hyderabad and Durg-Visakhapatnam. Union Minister Kishan Reddy, in a statement, revealed that after Delhi, Hyderabad will have the highest number of Vande Bharat trains.

In addition, Kishan Reddy spoke about the Prime Minister's commitment to the welfare of senior citizens through the Ayushman Bharat scheme. The government has extended health insurance coverage of up to Rs 5 lakhs for all individuals above 70 years of age, benefiting around 6 crore elderly people, irrespective of their financial status. The central government will spend Rs 3,437 crore on this scheme over the next two years, with an additional 10 lakh senior citizens from Telangana benefiting.

Special identity cards will be issued to all senior citizens above 70 years under this scheme. For families already covered by Ayushman Bharat, an additional Rs 5 lakh top-up health cover will be provided to senior citizens over 70 years of age.

Union Minister Kishan Reddy expressed his gratitude to Prime Minister Modi for his special attention to the elderly, noting that senior citizens across the country are happy with the government's decision.

CM Revanth Reddy Meets Central Team on Flood Damage Assessment

- Central team holds meeting with CM at the Secretariat.
- Appeal to establish a permanent fund for flood prevention.
- Call for long-term solutions to the flood issue.

TPN, **Telangana:** Chief Minister Revanth Reddy met with the central team at the Secretariat to discuss the assessment of flood damage in Telangana. The Telugu states have faced severe damage due to heavy rains and floods. In response, a central team visited Andhra Pradesh and Telangana to

evaluate the extent of the damage. The team members met with the Telangana CM at the Secretariat today.

During the meeting, CM Revanth Reddy requested that permanent measures be taken to prevent future floods in Telangana. He appealed

for the establishment of a permanent fund dedicated to flood prevention and emphasized the need for long-term solutions.

The Chief Minister highlighted the extent of the damage caused by floods in Telangana and requested the central team for immediate



relief funds without any preconditions. He also suggested that constructing a retaining wall along the Munneru River would provide a lasting solution to the recurring flood problem.

Health Minister Urges 2% CSR Contribution for Sangareddy Development

TPN, **Sangareddy:** Telangana Health Minister Damodar Raja Narasimha on Friday, September 13, urged corporates to allocate 2 percent of their corporate social responsibility (CSR) funds for the comprehensive development of Sangareddy district.



During a review meeting held at the district collector Kranti Vallur's office, Raja Narasimha encouraged representatives from large, medium, and small companies to focus their CSR efforts on the education, health, and social sectors of Sangareddy. He stressed the importance of completing projects under CSR

that would benefit the district's development.

According to data submitted by health officials regarding seasonal diseases recorded between January 1 and August 30, 2024, Telangana reported 6,242 dengue cases, 167 chikungunya cases, 197 malaria cases, and 2,99,708 viral fever cases.

To manage the dengue threat, the health department has conducted multiple surveys at regular intervals, testing 1,06,356 samples, with a 6 percent positivity rate. Hyderabad, Suryapet, and Medchal-Malkajgiri have been identified as the highest-risk districts for the disease.

Dy CM Urges Centre to Increase States' Share in Central Taxes to 50%

TPN, **Hyderabad:** Telangana Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka has called on the central government to increase states' share in central taxes to 50%, emphasizing the need for greater financial autonomy for economically progressive states. Speaking at a conference of finance ministers from five non-BJP-ruled states in Thiruvananthapuram, he urged the Centre to reduce cess and surcharges, which have resulted in states receiving less funding.

Vikramarka argued that despite the 14th Finance Commission's decision to raise states' share in central taxes from 32% to 42%, the actual resources allocated have not increased, as revenue from cesses and surcharges is not being shared. He pointed out that this has led to a 28% rise in the Centre's gross tax revenue, while states face substantial cuts in funding and delays in GST compensation, obstructing development programs.

The deputy CM also highlighted that southern states, though contributing 30% to the GDP, have seen their tax distribution share reduced from 21.073% to 15.800%. He



criticized centrally sponsored schemes for restricting states' autonomy by imposing stringent regulations and matching grant conditions.

On the proposal to redraw Lok Sabha constituency boundaries based on the 2011 census, Vikramarka expressed concern that this could diminish the political representation of southern states, which have prioritized population control and social development. He suggested adopting a system similar to the U.S., where the number of representatives has been capped.

Nandamuri Balakrishna Donates ₹50 Lakh to Telangana CM's Relief Fund

TPN, **Hyderabad:** Renowned actor and Hindupuram MLA Nandamuri Balakrishna has generously donated ₹50 lakh to the Telangana Chief Minister's Relief Fund to aid flood victims. On his behalf, his daughter Tejaswini presented the donation check to Chief Minister Revanth Reddy at the Secretariat.

During the presentation, Chief Minister Revanth Reddy expressed gratitude to all who supported the government and contributed to relief efforts. Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy and Sports Adviser AP Jitender Reddy were also present at the occasion.



NDSA Final Report on KLIS Barrages May Face Delays

TPN, **Hyderabad:** The State government is currently awaiting the final report from the National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA) concerning the Medigadda barrage and two other key barrages under the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Scheme (KLIS). This report is crucial for determining the next steps for the rehabilitation of these structures and may include recommendations for permanent solutions. However, the prospects of having these barrages operational by the next crop season, particularly for the Rabi season, appear increasingly uncertain.

The final report from the NDSA is now expected to be completed by the end of the year, with the potential for additional delays. The preparation of this report depends on several ongoing investigations managed by the state irrigation department, involving national agencies with specialized expertise. Minister for Irrigation N. Uttam Kumar Reddy has urged officials to expedite these investigations to facilitate a timely report.

In May, the NDSA provided an interim report recommending various temporary measures to be implemented before the monsoon season to preserve the current condition of the barrages. For Block-7 of Medigadda, the recommendations included monitoring cracks, reinforcing piers 16 to 22 to prevent lateral movement, and addressing defective pressure release valves in the raft.

Despite the limited timeframe, the irrigation department managed to execute a substantial portion of these interim measures, investing over Rs 60 crores. They also conducted necessary studies by engaging central agencies like the Central Soil and Materials Research Station (CSMRS) and the Central Water and Power Research Station (CWPRS).

However, further geophysical and geotechnical studies were hindered when parts of the barrage structures were submerged by early July floods. These investigations are expected to resume after floodwaters recede, likely around October, and are anticipated to take at least three months, pushing the completion date beyond December.

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BRS Proved Once Again That Activists Are Its True Strength

Our fearless cadres have once again proven that the true strength of BRS is in our united and strong cadre. Let us all work together to protect the pride, soul, and future of Telangana. Jai BRS, Jai Telangana," tweeted KTR.

Meanwhile, it is known that the challenges between BRS MLA Kaushik Reddy and Arikepudi Gandhi led to severe tensions on Thursday, ultimately resulting in several arrests.

Harish Rao's Suggestion to DGP and Police Officials



TPN, Telangana: Senior BRS MLA Harish Rao has advised the DGP and police officials not to blindly follow Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's directives. Speaking to the media at his residence in Kokapet, Harish Rao emphasized that the DGP holds a high-ranking and honorable position and should act responsibly while in this role. He alleged that in the past, Revanth Reddy had lashed out when placed under house arrest, incidents that are now circulating on social media.

Harish Rao pointed out that BRS leaders have been cooperating with the police and urged them not to blindly follow Revanth Reddy's instructions. He advised the police to act according to the law, even if Revanth Reddy suggests otherwise. Harish questioned why there was no action against Arikepudi Gandhi recently and criticized the lack of action when Kaushik Reddy was sent home and attacked.

He added that every stone thrown by Revanth Reddy would become a foundation stone for BRS and warned that if Revanth thought the BRS was afraid of such attacks, he was mistaken. Harish Rao stated that the BRS is no stranger to struggles and emphasized that they will continue to act in the best interest of Telangana. He also pointed out that the High Court has taken a strong stance on party defections and accused Revanth Reddy of engaging in diversionary politics. Harish Rao flagged that creating new issues to escape from existing problems is not the solution, and stressed that for the BRS, the state's welfare is more important than politics.

Don't Create Differences Between States: Minister Ponnam

TPN, Telangana: Senior Congress leader and Transport Minister Ponnam Prabhakar Goud warned against creating divisions between the peaceful Telugu states. Ponnam firmly stated that anyone attempting to tarnish Hyderabad's brand image will not be spared. He emphasized that peace and security must be preserved, and condemned house raids as improper conduct. He added that it is unacceptable to make comments about the separation of Telugu states, stressing that people from both regions live together like brothers and sisters.

Ponnam urged that differences between individuals should not be escalated into regional conflicts. Meanwhile, BRS MLAs, including Padi Kaushik Reddy, have been placed under house arrest by the police. Kaushik Reddy was prevented from leaving his house, with instructions to stay indoors. MLA Harish Rao was also detained by the police.

The tensions escalated when Padi Kaushik Reddy made provocative comments, suggesting that MLAs who switched parties should wear glasses and sarees. This led to a confrontation with Arikepudi Gandhi, who challenged Reddy by stating that he would visit Reddy's house and cover him with a BRS scarf. Kaushik Reddy responded with a challenge of his own.

In retaliation, Gandhi, accompanied by his followers, marched to Kaushik Reddy's house, sparking a tense situation. The group attempted to attack the residence with eggs, tomatoes, and stones, but the police intervened and prevented the attack. Following this, the scene shifted to the CP office, where Kaushik Reddy filed a complaint, claiming he was attacked. BRS workers then staged a protest in front of the CP office, but they were eventually dispersed by the police.



Bringing Regionalism to the Fore?: Danam Nagender

- Are Kaushik Reddy's comments reflective of the party's stance or personal opinions?
- Accusations of inciting tension in a peaceful state.
- Kaushik Reddy's capabilities are well known.

TPN, Telangana: MLA Danam Nagender expressed his anger, accusing BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy of bringing regionalism to the forefront. He questioned whether Kaushik Reddy's comments represented the party's stance or were merely personal opinions, demanding clarification from the BRS leadership on this issue. Nagender made these remarks while visiting Arikepudi



Gandhi's residence and emphasized the importance of maintaining peace in the

state.

He criticized the attempt to tarnish the large-scale meeting held at Arikepudi Gandhi's residence, suggesting that Kaushik Reddy's capacity and intentions were already well known. Nagender questioned why regionalism was being highlighted and called on the BRS to suspend Kaushik Reddy if his comments were personal.

He further questioned whether the BRS meeting at a private residence was organized with full awareness and understanding of the situation, asking for clarity from those involved.

BRS and YCP Singing the Same Tune?

G. Avinash Prudhvi: For a long time, the BRS and YCP have maintained a cordial relationship, as evidenced by the occasional meetings between YS Jaganmohan Reddy and KCR. However, with both parties currently out of power, their strategies have shifted accordingly.

If we look at recent political trends in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, it's becoming increasingly clear that the YCP and BRS are echoing each other's rhetoric—or perhaps more accurately, they seem to be living in the same delusional mindset.

On multiple occasions recently, including a press meet outside Guntur jail, Jagan boldly claimed that he will return as Chief Minister and warned TDP leaders of severe consequences. His exact words were, "when we come back, TDP leaders will be in these same jails."

Coincidentally, BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy, who has been involved in a public spat with Arikepudi Gandhi, made a strikingly similar statement. He said, "We will come to power in another four years, and then I will show Arikepudi Gandhi what I can do."

The clear pattern here is that both the BRS and YCP seem to be under the illusion that they will return to power and exact revenge on their political opponents. This mindset is far removed from the actual public sentiment and mandate in the Telugu states.

Instead of focusing on rebuilding their parties and staying relevant over the next few years, both BRS and YCP appear to be throwing empty threats at their opponents, based on hypothetical future power. These "shadow punches" serve no purpose for either party. If BRS and YCP are so confident of their return to power in four years, what's stopping the current ruling parties from taking action against them in the meantime?

Congress Women Leaders File Complaint to Speaker Seeking Disqualification of Padi Kaushik Reddy

- Kaushik Reddy said he would send sarees and bangles to MLAs who joined Congress.
- Congress women leaders express outrage over Kaushik Reddy's remarks.
- They demand action against Padi Kaushik Reddy.

TPN, Hyderabad: Congress women leaders filed a complaint against BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy with Speaker Prasad Kumar this afternoon. The leaders met the Speaker at the minister's residence in Hyderabad, expressing their anger over Kaushik Reddy's allegedly inappropriate and offensive comments directed at women. They demanded that strict action be taken against him.

The controversy stems from Kaushik Reddy's remarks in which he reportedly stated that he would send sarees and glasses to MLAs who were elected from BRS and later joined the Congress party. These comments have incensed Congress women leaders, who have warned BRS leaders to stop demeaning women.

- Criticizes Revanth Reddy's politics, claiming settlers are now suffering due to it.

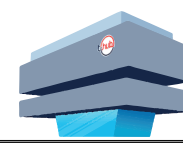

He emphasized that during the ten years of KCR's leadership, settlers did not face any hardships. Reddy recalled KCR's famous statement that he would remove any thorn in the settlers' path with his teeth if needed, reflecting his commitment to their welfare.

Kaushik Reddy pointed out that people from Andhra Pradesh respect KCR and the BRS leadership. He blamed Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's "lousy politics" for creating issues for the settlers.

Clarifying his recent remarks, Kaushik Reddy stated that he did not use the word "settlers" and that if he mentioned "Andhra," it was a personal matter between him and Arikepudi Gandhi. Infrastructure Developments The committee approved the construction of a new bridge connecting Secunderabad and Sitaphalmandi railway stations, utilizing the box-pushing method, with a budget of Rs 19.74 crore. In addition, it sanctioned the building of a multi-purpose function hall in NBT Nagar, Banjara Hills, costing Rs 3.85 crore. A pet animal crematorium will

also be constructed in Gopanpally, funded by the Raga Foundation, and a stormwater RCC box drain project was authorized for Majid Banda, with a budget of Rs 3.96 crore.

Environmental and Social Initiatives The committee supported the development of urban infrastructure, including rainwater harvesting structures in parks within Circle 20 of the Serilingampally zone, funded by the Water Aid Organisation. An MOU was signed with the Thuvakkam Welfare Association for creating an urban forest at KSR Layout, Serilingampally, spanning 43,600 square feet over three years. Furthermore, a partnership with the Malligavad Foundation was

established for the rejuvenation of Kaidamma Kunta in Hafeezpet under corporate social responsibility (CSR).

Administrative Updates GHMC also approved an increase in the pay scale for 90 community coordinators and organizers to Rs 24,280-Rs 72,850, effective from January 1, 2023. The committee authorized the procurement of 15,500 new LED streetlights at a total cost of Rs 2.98 crore and requested short tenders for this purchase. GHMC Commissioner Amrapali Kata, along with other committee members and officials, participated in the meeting, marking a significant step forward in Hyderabad's urban development efforts.

CP Anand: 25,000 Personnel Deployed for Ganesh Immersion



TPN Hyderabad : As the Ganesh Utsav celebrations approach their conclusion, Hyderabad Police Commissioner CV Anand has outlined the extensive preparations for the Ganesh immersion scheduled for September 17. Commissioner Anand reported that a robust team of 25,000 personnel has been mobilized to ensure the smooth and safe conduct of the immersion processions.

The immersion, including the major event at Khairatabad, will be managed with coordinated efforts across all departments. Anand highlighted that additional provisions have been made for areas identified as problematic. The Khairatabad Ganesh immersion is expected to be completed by 1:30 pm. This year has seen a 10% increase in the number of Ganesh idols, with the total estimated to be around one lakh. The immersion will span four days, with thousands of idols set to be immersed in Hussainsagar.

Regulations for Ganesh Immersion Processions

Hyderabad City Police have announced key regulations for the immersion processions to ensure public safety and order:

1. Only one vehicle per Ganesh idol is permitted.
2. Vehicles carrying idols must not have loudspeakers or DJ systems.
3. Confetti guns and musical systems are prohibited.
4. No alcohol or intoxicants are allowed on vehicles.
5. Vehicles should not obstruct traffic or stop near places of worship.
6. Adherence to traffic guidelines given by police officers is mandatory.
7. Carrying sticks, knives, firearms, or inflammable materials is prohibited.
8. Sticks for flags or decorations must not exceed 2 feet in length.
9. Throwing vermilion, saffron, or gulal at passers-by is not allowed.
10. Political or provocative speeches, slogans, and banners are banned.
11. Fireworks are prohibited during the procession.

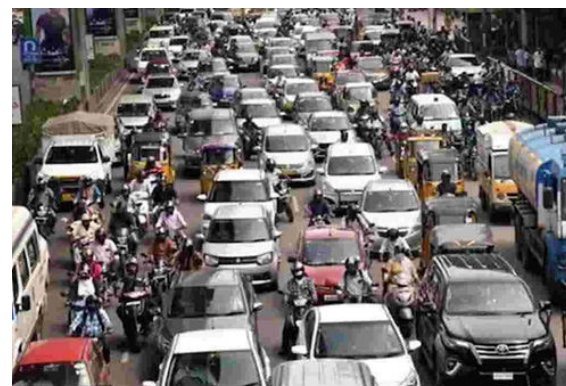
For emergencies, residents are advised to dial 100. The police department urges everyone to follow these regulations and cooperate with the officers to ensure a peaceful and orderly Ganesh immersion.

Note to Hyderabadis: 16 Days of Traffic Restrictions in Cyberabad Commissionerate

TPN Hyderabad : Police have announced traffic restrictions in the Cyberabad Commissionerate for approximately 16 days. From September 14 to 30, traffic will be diverted due to construction work on the service road from Cyber Towers flyover landing to Yashoda Hospital.

Important Traffic Changes:

1. Traffic traveling towards JNTU and Musapet via 100 Feet Junction from Toddy Compound should divert at Parvatnagar Junction and proceed via Khaitlapur Bridge.
2. Vehicles heading towards JNTU from Ikea, Cyber Gateway, and COD Junction via Cyber Towers Flyover should continue directly to JNTU.
3. Vehicles traveling towards JNTU under



the Cyber Towers flyover may be diverted at N-Grand Hotel and directed over to N-Convention.

Additionally, traffic restrictions will be in place in most parts of Bhagyanagar during Vinayaka Chavithi Namazjanam. Passengers using the IT Corridor are advised to take alternative routes.

Hyderabad Hosts Ozone Run to Raise Awareness on September 15

TPN Hyderabad : Hyderabad will host the "Ozone Run" on Sunday, September 15, at Gachibowli Stadium, starting at 5 a.m. The event, scheduled a day before the International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer, aims to raise awareness about the importance of protecting the ozone layer.

In its third edition, the Ozone Run also focuses on improving road hygiene in Hyderabad. The event will feature three race categories: 10K, 5K, and 2K. Registration fees for the races are set at Rs 1,050 for the 10K, Rs 850 for the 5K, and Rs 650 for the 2K.

One of the event organizers shared that a petition calling for better road hygiene will be signed during the run. This petition will be submitted to government officials and public



representatives to advocate for cleaner and safer streets.

Participants can register for the Ozone Run via the official website.

Tollywood Actor Scammed by Cybercriminals, Loses Rs. 45 Lakhs

TPN Hyderabad : Tollywood actor Bishnu Adhikari has fallen victim to a cyber scam, losing Rs. 45 lakhs to online fraudsters. The criminals deceived him by promising financial returns for completing tasks on YouTube. Believing the scam, Bishnu completed several tasks and even made additional investments, hoping for substantial earnings.

After finishing the tasks and investing a significant amount, Bishnu discovered that

he had been conned, as the cybercriminals disappeared after receiving Rs. 45 lakhs. The scam involved further tasks under the pretext of investments, leading to the substantial financial loss.

The authorities are currently investigating the case. Police are urging the public to remain cautious and avoid falling for similar online schemes or frauds.

Ganja Crackdown in Jubilee Hills

TPN Hyderabad : In Hyderabad, excise police conducted a crackdown on drug activity in the Jubilee Hills area, seizing 8.60 kg of ganja. A case has been registered against three individuals involved in the illegal trade, with two of them arrested. Authorities also confiscated a bike and two cell phones during the operation.

In a separate incident, police seized 220 grams of ganja and 11 grams of opium in the Shamirpet area, further intensifying their efforts to curb drug-related activities.



The enforcement team apprehended two men from Bihar, Chaman Kumar and Sainath, while they were on their way to deliver marijuana to a third person. The third accused, Rohan Kumar, also from Bihar, is currently absconding.

The investigation is ongoing as the police continue their efforts to locate the remaining suspect and dismantle drug operations in the city.

Huge Fraud Exposed in Madapur: Rs. 700 Crores Scam

TPN Hyderabad : A massive fraud involving Rs. 700 crores has come to light in Hyderabad, with over 18,000 victims across three states. The company at the center of this scam is Decaged Technologies, which lured investors with promises of high returns.

The company's managers initially collected up to Rs. 500 crores from unsuspecting investors, paying them back small amounts in the form of interest to gain their trust. Encouraged by the regular payouts, thousands of investors continued pouring in money.

However, the scam began to unravel when the company stopped making payments to its investors two months ago. When the victims realized they had been deceived, they filed complaints with the Hyderabad CCS (Central Crime Station) police.

The accused, identified as Mohammad Iqbal, Rahil, and DKZ, locked their office in Madapur and fled. They had earlier claimed to be selling essential items and electronic devices through their stores, furthering the illusion of a legitimate business.

The CCS police have registered a case and are actively investigating the scam. Thousands of victims are now seeking justice after falling prey to this fraudulent scheme.

Rachakonda Police Promote Road Safety with Eco-Friendly Ganesh Idol

Hyderabad: In a creative campaign to enhance road safety during the Ganesh Festival, the Rachakonda police shared a tweet on X (formerly Twitter) featuring an eco-friendly Ganesh idol secured with a seatbelt. The post cleverly combined tradition with a safety message, urging motorists to adopt responsible road behavior.

The tweet stated, "Even Lord Ganesha wore a seatbelt. Why don't we? Let's honor both tradition and safety by buckling up every time we're on the road." This initiative highlights the importance of both eco-friendly celebrations and road safety awareness, encouraging everyone to prioritize safety while enjoying the festivities.



Congress' Double Standards on PM-CJI Ganesh Puja Row Expose Its Hypocrisy



In the ever-evolving world of Indian politics, the lines between criticism, opportunism, and sheer hypocrisy often blur. The recent controversy surrounding Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Chief Justice of India (CJI) D.Y. Chandrachud's residence for Ganesh Chaturthi is a glaring example of this. While the Congress and other opposition parties have rushed to denounce the visit, accusing the Prime Minister of breaching the separation of powers between the judiciary and the executive, their outrage seems selective and misplaced when viewed in a broader context.

At the heart of the controversy is the claim that a visit by the Prime Minister to the CJI's home for a religious event sends an "uncomfortable message," as stated by RJD leader Manoj Jha. Congress and other parties argue that this private gathering undermines transparency and raises concerns about the impartiality of the judiciary. However, this criticism lacks substance, especially when contrasted with the historical precedent of similar gatherings involving political and judicial leaders.

Hypocrisy on Full Display

One of the most striking instances of Congress' selective outrage is their failure to recall that in 2009, then Prime Minister Manmohan Singh hosted an Iftar party that was attended by then Chief Justice KG Balakrishnan. This public event, which took place under the full scrutiny of the media and the public, was not criticized for undermining the separation of powers. Yet today, Congress seeks to differentiate between a public event like an Iftar and a private religious ceremony such as Ganesh Puja, arguing that the latter is somehow more problematic.

Congress' Mumbai unit, in its criticism of the Ganesh Puja, tried to draw a distinction between the two by saying that an Iftar party is a transparent, public event, while a private religious ceremony at someone's residence occurs away from public view. The implication here is that private religious gatherings are somehow more insidious or inappropriate when attended by political figures. This line of reasoning is flawed. Both Iftar and Ganesh Puja are religious observances, significant to millions of Indians. If anything, the criticism of the latter while ignoring the former reveals a deep-seated bias and a lack of consistency.



BJP's Rebuttal: A Lesson in Secularism

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) was quick to point out this hypocrisy. BJP spokesperson Shehzad Poonawalla rightly highlighted that "attending Ganesh Puja is no crime," emphasizing that the Congress has a long history of engaging in similar practices, but now seeks to demonize the Prime Minister for something as benign as attending a religious function. Union Minister Bhupender Yadav also hit back, stating that the sight of the executive and judiciary praying before Gods revered by millions of Indians reflects the strength of India's secular fabric.

India's brand of secularism is unique. It is not about rejecting religion or denying its place in public life but about respecting and embracing the diverse religious practices of its citizens. The Prime Minister attending Ganesh Puja, just like previous Prime Ministers attending Iftar or Christmas celebrations, exemplifies this inclusive form of secularism. To single out one event while condoning others exposes Congress' hypocrisy and raises questions about its motives.

A Flawed Argument on Separation of Powers

One of the most bizarre aspects of this controversy is the suggestion by some opposition leaders that the Chief Justice should recuse himself from hearing cases involving the government simply because of this visit. Sanjay Raut, a senior aide to former Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray, even questioned how

many homes the Prime Minister has visited and implied that such visits cast doubts on the judiciary's independence.

This argument is not only absurd but undermines the basic principles of trust in the judiciary. The Chief Justice of India, like any other citizen, is free to invite whomever he wishes to his home for religious ceremonies. Attending a Ganesh Puja does not suddenly make the CJI beholden to the Prime Minister, nor does it compromise his ability to adjudicate cases impartially. Such suggestions diminish the respect for the judiciary and create unnecessary distrust.

Political Opportunism at Its Best

The Congress' attempt to politicize a simple religious observance exposes its desperation and hypocrisy. By selectively criticizing Prime Minister Modi's visit to the CJI's home for Ganesh Puja, while conveniently forgetting similar gatherings during its own tenure, the Congress undermines its credibility.

India is a deeply religious country, and political leaders attending religious ceremonies, whether public or private, is not unusual. What is unusual is the opposition's sudden outrage and the inconsistency with which they apply their standards. In the end, this controversy reveals more about Congress' opportunistic politics than it does about any genuine concern for the separation of powers or the integrity of the judiciary. The party would do well to remember its own history before leveling baseless allegations.

Rahul Gandhi's Responsibilities as LOP: A Caution on Foreign Soil

Each time Rahul Gandhi embarks on a trip abroad, especially to Western nations, his speeches and comments often create ripples back in India. Whether it's his recent visit to the U.S. or previous trips to Europe, Gandhi has developed a reputation for making statements that stir controversy. However, this time there is added gravity to his words. Rahul Gandhi is no longer just a Congress MP or a member of the Gandhi family; he now holds the constitutionally significant position of Leader of the Opposition (LoP) in the Lok Sabha. This role not only increases the weight of his words but also calls for greater responsibility, especially when addressing international audiences.

A Global Platform with Serious Implications

While opposition leaders in democratic countries often criticize ruling governments, doing so on foreign soil can have deeper repercussions. Audiences abroad, particularly those unfamiliar with the intricacies of Indian politics, may take his statements at face value. This can create a skewed or negative perception of India, a country that has recently emerged as one of the fastest-growing economies in the world.

Rahul Gandhi's tendency to criticize not just Prime Minister Narendra Modi but also India's institutions, its people, and even its development progress on foreign platforms has become a concerning trend. His speeches are often interpreted as disparaging his own country rather than offering constructive criticism of government policies. This becomes problematic, as these platforms do not allow for an Indian domestic audience to fact-check or respond from their lived experiences, leading to a one-sided narrative that risks damaging India's global image.

Praise for China, Criticism of India

During his recent U.S. visit, Gandhi went so far as to praise China's advancements while simultaneously downplaying India's. He appeared indifferent to whether he wanted India to adopt China's political model or whether his portrayal of China's development was factually accurate. This type of rhetoric sends confusing signals about his vision for India and raises questions about the purpose of such comparisons.

The BJP and its supporters have been quick to capitalize on these statements, often framing Gandhi as a habitual offender of undermining India on foreign soil. When similar comments are made domestically, Indian citizens can form their own judgments. However, on an international platform, where many lack the context to understand the complexities of India's political landscape, these remarks can have unintended consequences.

Misrepresentation of Minorities

Perhaps the most controversial of Gandhi's recent remarks involved a question posed to a Sikh member of the audience in the U.S. He suggested that Sikhs in India face discrimination when it comes to wearing religious symbols like turbans or the tradi-

tional Kada. Such statements are not only misleading but also invoke painful memories of the 1984 anti-Sikh riots—a dark chapter in India's history, for which Congress itself has faced severe criticism. Ironically, Gandhi's remarks were immediately endorsed by Gurpatwant Singh Pannun, a known Khalistani separatist and anti-India activist. This endorsement should have prompted Gandhi to reconsider the potential ramifications of his comments, yet it was brushed aside.

While it is true that India has faced challenges in its long history with communal harmony, Gandhi's portrayal of the present situation is largely inaccurate. India today is a thriving democracy with an immense diversity of cultures, languages, and religions. His comments on American soil paint a picture of rampant religious persecution, which could not be further from reality.

Allegations About Indian Elections

Another contentious point raised by Rahul Gandhi was his claim that India's recent elections were "heavily controlled." Such remarks are a repeat of the narrative he pushed during his visit to London last year when he questioned the state of Indian democracy and urged Western nations to take note. Given that India is the world's largest democracy, such statements not only undermine the legitimacy of the election process but also discredit the millions of voters who actively participate in shaping the country's future. It is ironic that the very institution he questions, Indian democracy, has allowed him to hold significant positions of power over the years.

Ignoring Caste Realities in Jammu and Kashmir

Another topic of his speeches abroad is the ongoing caste survey in India, which he describes as an "x-ray" of Indian society. Gandhi frequently discusses this issue in states like Bihar, but his narrative conspicuously leaves out regions like Jammu and Kashmir, where caste-based reservations were denied until the abrogation of Article 370. This selective omission points to a political agenda that oversimplifies India's complex caste dynamics to suit his messaging.

Conclusion

As Leader of the Opposition, Rahul Gandhi's words carry considerable weight, especially on the global stage. His statements have the potential to influence international perceptions of India, for better or worse. While it is natural for opposition leaders to criticize government policies, doing so in a way that disparages the country and its institutions on foreign platforms is irresponsible. Gandhi must realize that his position demands a more balanced, thoughtful approach—one that criticizes constructively without misrepresenting his country or providing ammunition to forces that seek to harm India's image.

If Gandhi is to live up to the responsibilities of his role, he must exercise caution and mindfulness, particularly when speaking to international audiences unfamiliar with the subtleties of Indian politics.





Jagdish Tytler Pleads 'Not Guilty' in 1984 Anti-Sikh Riots Case, Trial to Begin in October

Congress leader Jagdish Tytler, accused of murder during the 1984 anti-Sikh riots, pleaded 'not guilty' to charges of murder and provocation with intent to cause a riot on Friday. The charges relate to the killing of three men outside Delhi's Pul Bangash gurdwara during the violent riots that followed the assassination of Prime Minister Indira Gandhi by her Sikh bodyguards.

The case, which has seen a delay of nearly four decades, will now move to trial, with the next hearing scheduled for October 3. Tytler, out on bail granted by a sessions court on a bond and surety of ₹1 lakh each, faces multiple charges, including unlawful assembly, rioting, disobedience to orders, and mischief by fire. The court had previously directed the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to frame charges based on sufficient evidence presented by the federal agency.

During Friday's hearing, Advocate HS Phoolka, representing the victims, expressed his disappointment at the delay in the trial. "It has taken 40 years for this trial to begin. It is very unfortunate and shows how a powerful person can cripple the whole system. Hopefully, the trial will conclude soon, and he will be jailed," he remarked.

The CBI, in its chargesheet filed in May last year, accused Tytler, then a Member of Parliament, of inciting and provoking a mob near the Pul Bangash gurdwara in November 1984, which led to the deaths of three men. Several eyewitnesses have claimed to have seen Tytler at the scene, urging the mob to carry out his instructions.

Tytler, however, has consistently denied the charges, stating there is no evidence against him. "If there is evidence against me, I'm prepared to hang myself," he said in August last year. Jagdish Tytler's involvement in the 1984 riots has long been a point of controversy for the Congress party, with opposition parties accusing the party of shielding its leaders. In 2012, then-Prime Minister Manmohan Singh issued a public apology for the riots, followed by apologies from senior Congress leaders Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi.

Siddaramaiah Calls for 9-State Strategy Session on Central Fund Allocation

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah has written to the Chief Ministers of eight states, urging a joint strategy session to negotiate a fairer financial deal for states that contribute more to the Central government's coffers. The states include Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Haryana, and Punjab. Siddaramaiah argues that wealthier states are being unfairly penalized for their economic success, which undermines cooperative federalism and threatens the financial autonomy of progressive states.

Siddaramaiah's Kerala counterpart, Pinarayi Vijayan, has expressed support, emphasizing the need for these states to unite and fight for a fairer share, warning that fiscal federalism is under threat.

The appeal comes ahead of the 16th Finance Commission's finalization of the criteria for devolution of Central funds. Finance ministers from Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, and Punjab have already met in Thiruvananthapuram to form a consensus on their recommendations to the Commission.

Southern states, which contribute 30% of India's GDP but house only 19.6% of its population, have seen their share of tax devolution drop. Karnataka receives just 15 paise for every rupee it contributes to the Union, while Kerala and Tamil Nadu get 25 and 29 paise, respectively. In contrast, Uttar Pradesh receives ₹2.73 and Bihar ₹7.06 for every rupee they contribute.

The states demand an increase in their share of Central taxes, from the current 41% to 50%. They also argue that demographic discipline and good governance should not be punished, and Centrally sponsored schemes should be reduced to allow more local spending.

Arvind Kejriwal Granted Bail After 6 Months, Restricted from Office and Signing Files

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has been granted bail by the Supreme Court after nearly six months in jail following his arrest by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) in connection with the alleged liquor excise policy case. The Supreme Court ruled that Kejriwal's prolonged incarceration "amounts to unjust deprivation of liberty."

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader can now leave jail, having already secured bail in a related case filed by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act. However, his release comes with significant restrictions. Kejriwal is barred from going to his office, the Delhi Secretariat, or signing files without the consent of Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena.

In a hearing held on Friday morning, a bench comprising Justice Ujjal Bhuyan and Justice Surya Kant delivered separate verdicts on Kejriwal's pleas but agreed that he must be released from jail. Kejriwal had also challenged the CBI's arrest, terming it an "insurance arrest" as it came shortly after he was granted bail in the ED case. On this matter, the judges differed, with Justice Kant finding no issue with the CBI's arrest, while Justice Bhuyan questioned the timing of the agency's actions.

However, both judges agreed that keeping Kejriwal in jail without a trial was unjust, noting that the completion of the trial was unlikely in the near future. The court's ruling echoed earlier decisions in similar cases, such as those involving former Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia and Telangana leader K. Kavitha, who were also released on bail under similar circumstances.

Justice Bhuyan strongly emphasized the legal principle that "bail is the rule, jail is the exception," criticizing the CBI's urgency in arresting Kejriwal when he was about to be released in the ED case.

Reacting to the decision, Kejriwal's wife, Sunita Kejriwal, expressed her relief and accused the BJP of attempting to jail opposition leaders to stay in power.



Kattar Beimaan, Bail Wala...": BJP Criticizes Arvind Kejriwal's Bail

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has been granted bail by the Supreme Court after six months in Tihar Jail, but with significant restrictions. The court ruled that Kejriwal cannot visit his office or the Delhi Secretariat while on bail, nor can he sign off on government files without the Lieutenant Governor's consent. The BJP swiftly reacted to the court's decision with sharp criticism. BJP leader Gaurav Bhatia derided Kejriwal as "kattar beimaan" (outright dishonest) and "bail wala" (bail man), stating, "The Supreme Court has shown a mirror to Arvind Kejriwal. He has now moved from 'jail wala' to 'bail wala.'" The BJP has also reiterated its demand for Kejriwal's resignation, questioning his morality and fitness for office.

Delhi BJP chief Virendra Sachdeva echoed these sentiments, arguing that Kejriwal should step down if he cannot perform his duties due to the bail conditions. The court had earlier ruled on the charges against Kejriwal, with differing opinions on the legality of the CBI's arrest. Justice Surya Kant found no issue with the arrest, while Justice Ujjal Bhuyan questioned the timing.

Kejriwal was first arrested by the Enforcement Directorate on March 21, and later by the CBI on June 26. His legal team has criticized the CBI's actions as an "insurance" move to keep him in custody. In contrast, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) celebrated Kejriwal's release, with his wife Sunita Kejriwal and other party leaders expressing joy and relief. AAP MP Raghav Chadha welcomed Kejriwal back, stating, "Welcome back, Arvind Kejriwal, we missed you!"



Port Blair Renamed as Srivijayapuram, Reflecting India's Freedom Struggle

TPN, New Delhi: In a significant move, the capital of the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Port Blair, has been renamed Srivijayapuram. Union Home Minister Amit Shah announced the decision, stating that the name change is a symbolic move to shed colonial legacies and honor India's freedom struggle.

"Port Blair represented colonial tendencies, while Srivijayapuram signifies the triumph of our freedom movement and the unique role that the Andaman and Nicobar Islands played in it," Amit Shah said. He emphasized the historical importance of the islands, noting their profound contribution to India's independence.

Amit Shah further highlighted that the islands were once a naval base for the Cholas, an empire known for its maritime strength. Today, Andaman and Nicobar Islands have become a strategically significant base for India, strengthening the country's naval capabilities.

The Home Minister also reminded the nation that it was here, in the Andaman Islands, that Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose first hoisted the Tricolor flag, marking a pivotal moment in India's independence journey. He also referenced the Cellular Jail in Port Blair, where freedom fighter Veer Savarkar was imprisoned, underscoring the deep historical connection between the islands and the freedom movement.



Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw Travels By Local Train in Mumbai, Engages with Commuters

On Friday, Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw took a ride on Mumbai's local train network, engaging with commuters to understand their concerns. Boarding the suburban train at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus at 2:34 PM, Vaishnaw traveled 27 kilometers, alighting at Bhandup station at 3:18 PM.

Vaishnaw, who was in Mumbai for an awards ceremony, chose a second-class coach on the Ambernath-bound slow local train. During the journey, he interacted with passengers who raised issues regarding the need for increased services and frequent disruptions.

Addressing the media onboard, Vaishnaw highlighted 12 major projects underway in the Mumbai metropolitan region, costing ₹16,240 crore. These projects aim to add 301 kilometers of tracks, including the 5th and 6th lines between CSMT-Kurla, the 6th line between Mumbai Central-Borivali, and several other key expansions. He assured that these developments would enhance the commuter experience by increasing capacity and reducing delays.

Central Railway General Manager Dharam Veer Meena and other officials accompanied Vaishnaw during the trip. The minister is also set to visit a Ganesh mandal as part of the ongoing Ganesh festival celebrations.

Conspiracy Theories Spark as Kamala Harris's Debate Earrings Attract Attention

In the wake of the fiercely contested US presidential debate between Vice President Kamala Harris and former President Donald Trump, conspiracy theories have emerged regarding Harris's choice of earrings. whether Mrs Harris wore one of our products. The resemblance is striking," while humorously suggesting the creation of a male version for

Trump, with the color orange posing a design challenge.

Despite the viral claims, experts and fact-checkers have clarified that Harris's earrings were not Bluetooth devices but the Double Pearl Hinged Earrings from Tiffany & Co., priced at around \$800. In contrast, Icebach's audio earrings retail for approximately \$625. Harris, who has previously criticized Bluetooth earpieces as security risks, was often seen using wired earbuds during her campaign. This incident is reminiscent of similar conspiracy theories that surfaced during the 2020 and 2016 election cycles, where allegations were made that Joe Biden and Hillary Clinton used earpieces during debates against Trump. The heightened scrutiny surrounding Harris's appearance in the debate highlights the growing

mistrust and speculation in political arenas.

In a surprising twist, Icebach Sound Solutions has embraced the media frenzy, announcing plans to address the rumors in a forthcoming interview on **The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon**. The company revealed that they had received numerous interview requests and chose Fallon, describing him as a "trusted Bavarian in heart," for their live appearance.

Meanwhile, Trump appears to have rejected any further debate with Harris, taking to Truth Social to announce, "THERE WILL BE NO THIRD DEBATE!" For now, the viral speculation surrounding Harris's earrings seems destined to remain a humorous footnote in an otherwise heated political landscape.



Taylor Swift Endorses Kamala Harris for 2024 Presidential Election, JD Vance Responds

Pop icon Taylor Swift has publicly endorsed Kamala Harris for the 2024 Presidential Election, voicing her support for the Democratic Vice President in an Instagram post on Tuesday. Swift praised Harris as a "steady-handed, gifted leader," adding that Harris embodies the calm and leadership the country needs. Swift's endorsement has gained widespread attention, drawing nearly 10 million likes.

In her post, Swift urged her followers to research candidates before making their decisions, sharing that she had done her own research and concluded that Kamala Harris was the leader she believed in. She also took the opportunity to endorse Minnesota Governor Tim Walz for reelection.

Swift signed off her post by dubbing herself a "childless cat lady," a direct jab at Republican JD Vance, who once sarcastically referred to Democrats as a "bunch of childless cat ladies" in a 2021 interview.

Biden to Host Fourth In-Person Quad Summit in Delaware on September 21

President Joe Biden is set to host the fourth in-person Quad Leaders Summit in Wilmington, Delaware, on September 21, focusing on strengthening strategic cooperation and advancing a shared vision for a free and open Indo-Pacific region. The White House confirmed the attendance of key Quad leaders, including Prime Minister Narendra Modi of India, Prime Minister Anthony Albanese of Australia, and Prime Minister Kishida Fumio of Japan.

"This will be President Biden's first time hosting foreign leaders in Wilmington as president—a reflection of his deep personal relationships with each of the Quad Leaders, and the importance of the Quad to all of our countries," White House Press Secretary Karine Jean-Pierre said in a statement on Thursday. The Quad, a diplomatic partnership among the United States, Australia, India, and Japan, has become a cornerstone of the Biden administration's strategy in the Indo-Pacific region. Since its inaugural leaders' summit at the

White House in 2021, the group has held annual summits and frequent meetings at various levels, including eight gatherings of the Quad Foreign Ministers.

According to the White House, the upcoming summit will highlight "bolstering the strategic convergence among our countries" while addressing key issues such as health security, maritime security, disaster response, infrastructure, emerging technologies, climate change, clean energy, and cybersecurity.

By hosting this summit, President Biden continues to emphasize the administration's priority of elevating and institutionalizing the Quad partnership. The meeting also underscores the shared commitment of Quad nations to upholding a rules-based order in the Indo-Pacific, countering growing regional challenges. The next Quad Summit will be hosted by India, further strengthening collaboration between the four nations in key areas affecting the Indo-Pacific region.

Brazilian Aircraft Maker Embraer Seeks Indian Suppliers for Defence



Brazilian aircraft manufacturer Embraer is looking to expand its supply chain by partnering with suppliers from India across its defence, commercial aviation, and executive jet businesses. The company, which already has a significant presence in the Indian market with 44 aircraft in operation, views India as a strategic hub for its growth.

A high-level delegation from Embraer is concluding its visit to India this week, exploring potential Indian suppliers for various critical areas, including aerostructures, machining, sheet metal, composites, forgings, wire harnesses, and hardware and software development, according to a company release on Thursday.

"India has a robust aviation and defense industry, and we see strong viability for manufacturers and systems developers in India to be key suppliers to Embraer," said Roberto Chaves, Executive Vice-President of Global Procurement and Supply Chain at Embraer.

The move comes as Embraer seeks to tap into India's growing expertise in aviation and defense manufacturing. The company also hinted at a potential collaboration with Indian conglomerate Mahindra for the local supply chain program, which could involve the assembly of Embraer's C-390 aircraft in India, should the aircraft be selected for future defense programs.

The visit underscores Embraer's commitment to deepening its ties with Indian industries across its commercial, executive, and defense segments, as it continues to identify key partners in India to enhance its global supply chain.



Markets End with Modest Losses Amid Global Uncertainty

IT, Metal, and PSU Banks Shine Despite FMCG Decline

Indices, which touched lifetime highs in the previous session, ended with moderate losses on Friday. International markets have received mixed signals. Investors have acted with caution. Not inclined to buy. As a result, Sensex fell by 71 points and Nifty by 32 points. The market in BSE is in favor of buyers. 2483 stocks rose and 1473 fell. The rupee gained 7 paise to settle at 83.90 against the dollar.

The BSE Sensex, which closed at 82,962 in the previous session, opened at 83,091 today. It touched an intraday low of 82,653, peaked at 83,092. It eventually closed down 71 points at 82,890. The NSE Nifty opened at 25,430 and touched a low of 25,292 and a high of 25,430. A total loss of 32 points closed at 25,356. Bank Nifty rose 165 points to settle at 51,938.

In Nifty50, 18 companies gained while 32 lost. Wipro, Bajaj Finserv, Bajaj Finance, Grasim, Indus Ind Bank were the top gainers. SBI Life, Adani Ports, HDFC Life, ITC, Coal India are the top losers. FMCG, Healthcare, Oil and Gas indices turned red today. IT, Media, Metal, PSU Bank, Realty and Consumer Durables indices were upbeat.

RBI Governor Comments on CPI Inflation Trends

On Friday, Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Governor Shaktikanta Das addressed the current state of consumer price index (CPI) inflation, noting that despite its recent moderation, there remains significant progress to be made. The Governor's remarks follow a report from the National Statistical Office (NSO) which indicated a slight increase in CPI inflation to 3.65% in August, up from July's five-year low of 3.60%.

Governor Das acknowledged the CPI inflation rate has softened and is now within the RBI's tolerance band of 2-6%. However, he emphasized that while this is a positive development, the inflation rate still has some distance to cover before it aligns with the central bank's comfort zone.

The marginal rise in CPI inflation from July to August suggests a subtle shift, but it remains well within the acceptable range set by the RBI. The RBI continues to monitor inflationary trends closely, considering both domestic and



global economic factors that could influence future adjustments in monetary policy.

Das's comments reflect the RBI's cautious stance as it balances the need to support economic growth while keeping inflationary pressures in check. The central bank's ongoing assessment of inflation trends will play a crucial role in shaping its policy decisions moving forward.

FORD TO RESUME OPERATIONS IN TAMIL NADU WITH FOCUS ON EXPORTS

Ford Motor Company is set to resume operations in Tamil Nadu, signaling a significant shift after a brief hiatus. The American automaker has submitted a 'Letter of Intent' to the Tamil Nadu Government, marking a positive development following its cessation of sales in India in 2021 and halt of exports in 2022.



This decision follows a fruitful discussion between Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin and Ford's leadership in the U.S. Ford announced that it will re-purpose its Chennai plant to focus primarily on exporting to global markets. While specific details on manufacturing activities remain undisclosed, this move represents a strategic adjustment in Ford's India operations.

Ford's presence in Tamil Nadu has been significant, with over 12,000 employees. The company's plan to restart operations is anticipated to create an additional 3,000 jobs over the next three years, boosting the local economy.

Sources from the industries department revealed that Tamil Nadu's proactive engagement with Ford's leadership played a crucial role in this decision. Industries Minister T.R.B. Rajaa's visits to the U.S. since 2023 showcased the state's advancements in automotive and electric vehicle sectors, which helped persuade Ford. The Tamil Nadu government's assurances of a smooth reintegration into the Indian market were pivotal in finalizing the deal.

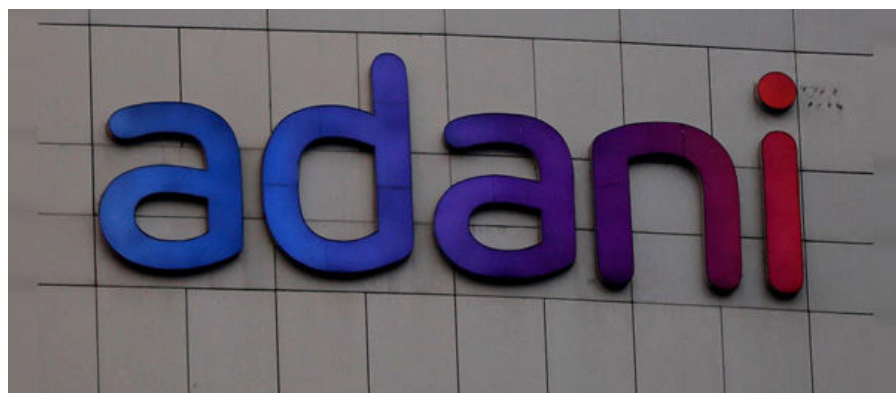
Ford had requested six months to decide on its return to India, and the recent developments reflect the success of Tamil Nadu's efforts in attracting major automotive investments.

Crude Prices Hit Near Three-Year Low, Impact on Inflation and Economy

Brent crude oil prices are bearing a three-year low, trading around \$70 per barrel. This decline has led to a 6 percent drop in the Indian crude basket in September compared to the previous month, and prices are now 21 percent lower than last year's levels. While the decrease in crude oil prices is expected to help control wholesale inflation, its ultimate effect on consumer inflation will depend on how much of the savings are passed on to consumers.

The current low prices of crude oil are likely to benefit the government by reducing the current account deficit and boosting revenues. However, there are potential downsides. Lower crude oil prices could impact fiscal mathematics by



reducing nominal growth, which in turn could affect the fiscal deficit, as it is calculated as a percentage of nominal GDP.

Xi Jinping Tightens Ideological Grip Amid China's Economic and Social Struggles

In a series of sweeping initiatives, China under President Xi Jinping is moving to tighten its ideological grip over civil society, education, and even the military, signaling a shift towards more intense state control. From introducing digital identification for internet users to reshaping the education system and solidifying military discipline, Xi's policies reflect his vision of "national rejuvenation" and the preservation of the Communist Party of China's (CPC) dominance.

Digital Identification: Strengthening Online Control

One of the most notable developments is the proposal to introduce digital identification for Chinese netizens. Spearheaded by China's Cyberspace Administration and the Ministry of Public Security, this initiative aims to replace real identities with digital IDs for online profiles. While authorities argue this move is intended to protect users' personal data from being stored by private platforms, concerns have emerged about the potential for increased state surveillance and control over online activities.

Education as an Ideological Battlefield



The education sector is a crucial arena for Xi's ideological ambitions. In recent months, the CPC has rolled out new regulations aimed at improving the status of teachers while ensuring their alignment with Party principles. With over 18 million educators in China, the new guidelines not only seek to enhance their skills but also ensure they adhere to the Party's line, pushing educators to instill a strong sense of nationalism in students. and symbols, is a clear attempt to align education with his ideological objectives. By emphasizing the importance of ideological guidance, Xi seeks to cement the Party's influence over future generations, ensuring that students become "socialist successors" loyal to the CPC.



Protecting China from "Hostile Forces"

Xi has also framed his ideological tightening as a defensive measure against external threats. In an article published in the CPC journal "Qiushi", Xi warned of Western efforts to destabilize China through a "color revolution"—a term used to describe uprisings aimed at overthrowing authoritarian regimes. He argued that China's youth are particularly vulnerable to such threats, especially through pop culture and social media, which he believes could be used by foreign intelligence agencies for recruitment and infiltration.

In response, China has introduced new textbooks focused on national security, aimed at weaning students away from potentially subversive influences. These moves are part of a broader strategy to maintain control over public discourse and prevent any form of dissent that could undermine the Party's authority.

The PLA Under Xi: Restoring Discipline and Loyalty

Xi's ideological oversight extends to the People's Liberation Army (PLA) as well. As chairperson of the Central Military Commission (CMC), Xi has called for a rectification of the PLA, citing "lax discipline" as a persistent problem under his predecessors. Drawing parallels to Mao Zedong's Yan'an Rectification campaign of the 1940s, Xi seeks to strengthen the Party's control over the military by ensuring that only those loyal to the CPC rise through the ranks.

This ideological purification of the PLA underscores Xi's belief that the Party's strength is inextricably

linked to the military's loyalty. The appointment of figures like He Hongjun, who has taken a leading role in political work within the CMC, reflects Xi's determination to staff the PLA with individuals who are not only capable but also ideologically aligned with the CPC.

An Economy in Decline: The Real Trigger for Control

Xi's tightening grip comes at a time when China's economic fortunes are faltering. The country's GDP growth has struggled to meet targets, with factory output stagnating and real estate sales hitting an 18-year low. Unemployment has risen sharply, particularly among the youth, prompting the government to stop publishing unemployment statistics altogether. Labour unrest has also increased, with strikes and protests becoming more frequent.

The economic slowdown, exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic, has led to growing social unrest, as seen in the widespread demonstrations in December 2022 against harsh COVID restrictions. In response, the Party has doubled down on control, seeking to preempt any further challenges to its authority.



A Bid for Survival

Xi Jinping's ideological tightening across various sectors of Chinese society is a calculated response to the growing economic and social challenges facing the nation. By increasing control over the internet, education, and the military, Xi is ensuring that the Party remains the central force in Chinese life, even as discontent rises. His fear of a "color revolution" and the collapse of Party authority, as seen in the Soviet Union, drives these efforts. As China's economy continues to struggle, Xi's grip on power is likely to become even firmer, with ideological control playing a key role in the Party's survival.

CCI Report Accuses Amazon and Flipkart of Anti-Competitive Practices



India's Competition Commission (CCI) has released extensive reports accusing Amazon and Flipkart of breaching local competition laws. The investigations, which span over 2,700 pages, assert that both e-commerce giants engaged in practices that unfairly favored select sellers on their platforms, thus disadvantaging others.

According to the reports, Amazon and Flipkart promoted specific sellers with whom they had business agreements, allowing these sellers to appear higher in search results. This preferential treatment, the CCI found, led to an "ecosystem" where other sellers were pushed out of the spotlight.

The findings, dated August 9, conclude that ordinary sellers were relegated to "mere database entries" while preferred sellers enjoyed advantages such as enhanced visibility and lower costs for marketing and delivery services. The reports also highlight the impact of these practices on competition, noting that deep discounting—particularly in the sale of mobile phones—constituted "predatory pricing" and harmed market dynamics.

The CCI's investigation was spurred by a complaint from the Delhi Vyapar Mahasangh, an affiliate of the Confederation of All India Traders, which represents millions of retailers. CAIT has welcomed the findings and plans to escalate the matter to the federal government.

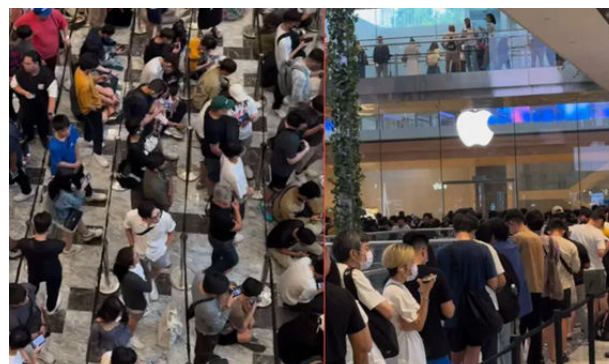

India on Verge of Historic Test Cricket Milestone

As the teams prepare for this showdown, fans can expect another memorable chapter in this storied hockey rivalry.

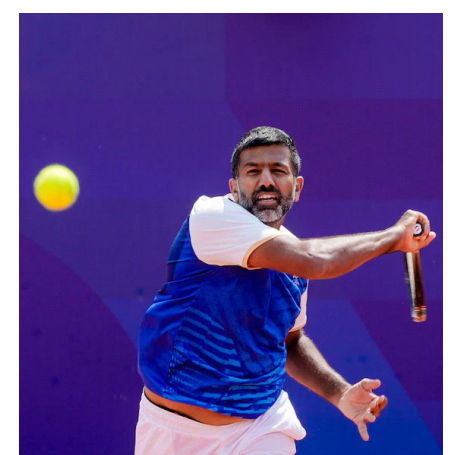


Rohan Bopanna to Make Tennis Premier League Debut in Season 6

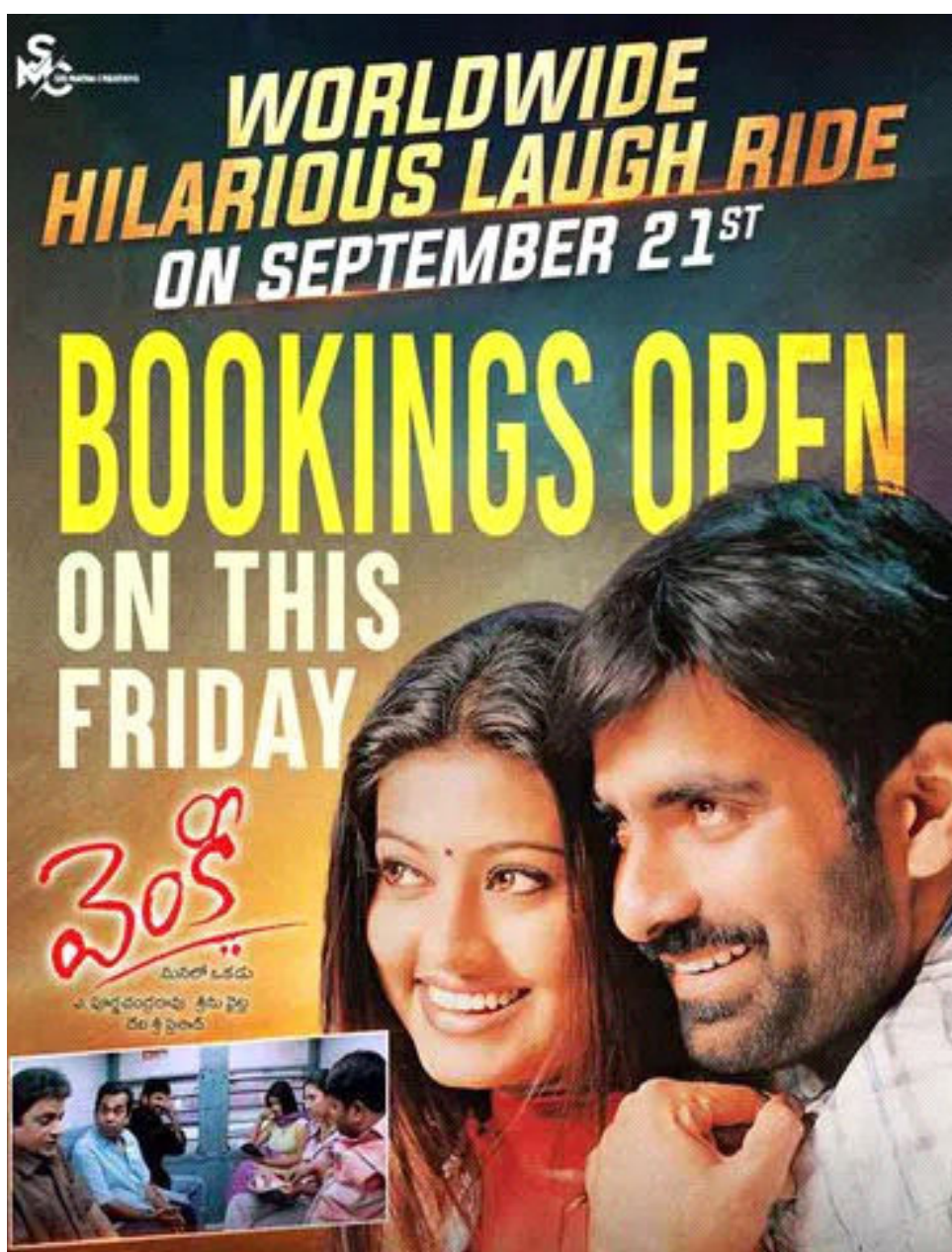

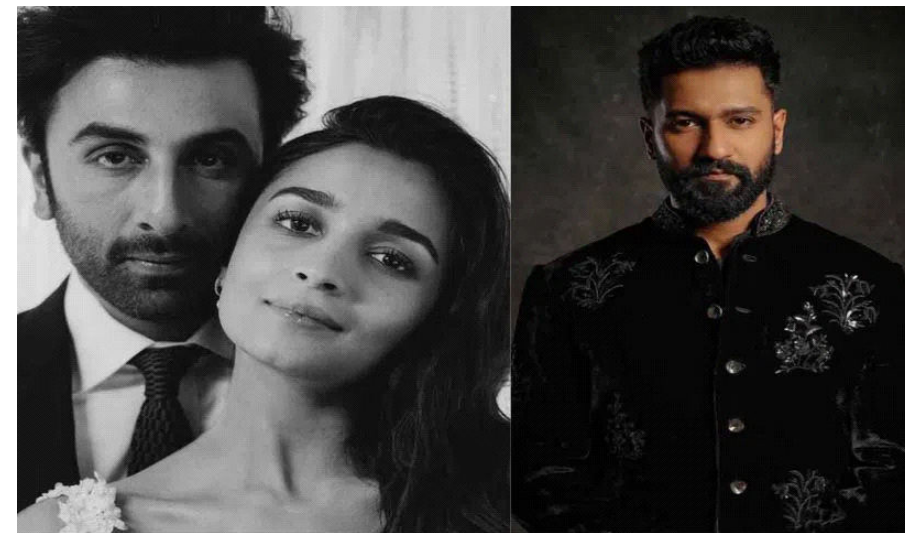
Ravi Teja's Venky Returns to Theaters on September 21
