CM Revanth Reddy Unveils New MSME Policy, Aims to Boost Industrial Growth

AMP is a \$808 Mn (Rs. 6,000 Cr.) World Bank assisted program to support MSMEs across India. Telangana submitted the required Strategic Investment Plan with 14 proposed projects. The Ministry of MSME of which 10 projects received approval and funding.



TPN, Hyderabad: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy launched the MSME Policy-2024 on Wednesday, highlighting the state's potential to challenge global economies and positioning Hyderabad as a prime destination for business and investment.

Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), such as land access, capital availability, and technical support. As part of the initiatives, 20% of plots in upcoming industrial parks will be reserved for MSMEs, and 10 new industrial parks will be established around Hyderabad to encourage growth.

To ensure efficient implementation, a high-level steering committee will be set up to oversee the progress of these initiatives. The CM underscored the government's commitment to positioning Telangana as a global leader in industrial development, driven by proactive policies that

support MSMEs and foster industrial progress across the state.

Fruits of Development Beyond Party Lines

Chief Minister Revanth Reddy highlighted that the Congress government is focused on delivering development benefits irrespective of political affiliations. On Wednesday, the state launched the new MSME Policy-2024 to support small and medium enterprises. Speaking at the event in Madapur, Revanth emphasized the importance of encouraging MSMEs to boost employment and enhance the state's wealth.

Revanth praised Prime Minister PV Narasimha Rao for his visionary policies during economic crises and commended Minister Sridhar Babu for his forward-thinking approach. He asserted that development is a continuous process that transcends politics, stressing that good governance is not about political gains but about advancing state interests.

The CM also addressed the gap between educational and industrial needs, noting the conversion of 65 ITIs into advanced technology centers with an investment of Rs. 2,400 crores in collaboration with Tata Institute.

He announced the establishment of the Young India Skills University, supported by a corpus fund from industrialists, to align skills training with industry demands.

The CM pledged to develop Hyderabad's future city with a focus on life sciences and green pharma. He committed to improving support for self-help groups, including expanding marketing facilities and increasing financial support for school uniforms. He reaffirmed the government's dedication to strengthening MSMEs and ensuring their success in driving job creation and economic growth.



High Court orders demolition of BRS party office in Nalgonda

TPN, Telangana: The Telangana High Court delivered a significant blow to the BRS party, ordering the demolition of its party office in Nalgonda. The court imposed a 15-day deadline for the demolition and fined the party Rs. 1 lakh.

In full detail, Minister Komatireddy Venkatareddy ordered municipal officials to demolish the illegal construction of the BRS party office in Nalgonda, which was built without any proper permissions. Following this, the municipal authorities prepared to proceed with the demolition. In response, the BRS party approached the High Court, seeking directions to have their office regularized.

During the hearing, the High Court made notable observations. It questioned how the party could seek permission for the building after its construction was already completed. 'Permission should be taken before building the party office. How can you seek permission after construction?' the court remarked.

The court directed municipal officials to demolish the party office within 15 days and imposed a Rs. 1 lakh fine on the BRS party.

Cyberabad Police Intensify Efforts to Nab Jani Master Over Sexual Assault Case

TPN, Hyderabad: The Cyberabad police have intensified their efforts to apprehend choreographer Shaik Jani, also known as Jani Master, who is accused of sexually assaulting a woman assistant choreographer.

The victim filed a complaint at the Raidurgam police station last week, leading to the registration of a case against Jani Master. The case was subsequently transferred to the Narsingi police station due to jurisdictional reasons. The woman alleged that she began working as an assistant choreographer for Jani Master and was sexually assaulted multiple times during film shoots. She also claimed that Jani Master threatened to kill her if she disclosed the assaults to anyone. The police have received information that Jani Master may have fled to a location in North India, and a team has been dispatched to apprehend him.

Additionally, the police have added sections of the POCSO Act to the case after the victim revealed that she was a minor at the time of the assaults. Her statement was recorded at the Bharosa Centre, leading to the invocation of POCSO sections against Jani Master. In a related development, local leader Karate Kalyani alleged that the case is a form of 'love jihad,' claiming that Jani Master had enticed the girl and was coercing her to convert to Islam.



KCR's Achievements Are Unshakeable, Says KTR



TPN, Hyderabad: BRS Party Working President K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) emphasized that the achievements of former Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) cannot be erased, citing recent economic data to highlight Telangana's growth. KTR's remarks come in the wake of a report by Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Economic Advisory Council, which highlighted Telangana's significant progress in per capita income.

'Statistics never lie, and this report confirms the exceptional development Telangana has seen under KCR's leadership,' KTR stated. He pointed out that Telangana's per capita income is 94 percent higher than the national average, a feat achieved in just nine and a half years since the state's formation.

KTR used the report to showcase how Telangana has become a model for development across all sectors, attributing this success to KCR's governance. 'The economic progress made by Telangana is undeniable, and the report is a testament to KCR's vision for the state's growth,' he tweeted. KTR's comments reinforce the BRS party's claims of strong leadership and sustained economic progress under KCR's regime.



**TPN, Hyderabad:** The Bhadrachalam Sri Seetha Ramachandra Swamy Devasthanam has accused a US-based Lord Rama temple of misusing its name for fundraising purposes. The temple authorities are considering legal action to stop the alleged misuse, as the US-based organization is said to be collecting donations using the name of the Bhadradi Temple.

An organization in Cumming, Georgia, known as \*Bhadradi Sri Rama Temple of USA\*, chaired by priest Archakam Padmanabha Acharyulu, has been performing rituals worldwide and is slated to conduct a \*kalyanam\* at Bhadrachalam on September 17. The US temple organizers have been accused of using the Bhadradi Temple's name to solicit donations for the construction of their temple, prompting concerns from

Bhadrachalam temple officials.

The executive officer of Bhadrachalam Temple, L. Rama Devi, stated that any other organization using the Bhadradi Sri Rama name was improper, and clarified that the Bhadrachalam temple had no affiliation with the US temple. She added that a complaint had been lodged with the Endowment department, and legal action would be taken against the US temple organizers.

While the Bhadradi Temple authorities are contemplating applying for a patent on the temple's name, legal experts argue that patent laws do not cover names or titles.

Meanwhile, Padmanabha Acharyulu, the chief priest of the US temple, denied the allegations,

stating that their temple is being built with good intentions and not for profit. He pointed out that similar temples and organizations across the world have used the name "Bhadradi" and noted that the Bhadrachalam temple authorities had not raised any objections in the past nine years. Acharyulu emphasized that their US temple's name differs from the Bhadrachalam temple, and there has been no patent or copyright claim by the Bhadrachalam authorities on the temple's name or its deities' images.

The situation has escalated after Bhadradi Temple officials issued notices to two priests for their involvement in the upcoming \*kalyanam\*. The dispute has attracted significant attention as both parties continue to defend their positions.

## KTR warns Jupalli Krishna Rao for Insulting Dalits

**TPN, Telangana:** BRS Working President KTR has strongly criticized Excise Minister Jupalli Krishna Rao for his treatment of Dalits. KTR questioned why such harshness is shown towards Dalits who seek justice for their land rather than unjustly taking it. He expressed concern that the Congress government's actions could lead to significant backlash.

The issue arose when the Congress government selected Dalit land for constructing an integrated gurukula school in Jataprol village, Kolhapur constituency. KTR highlighted that the affected Dalit children only sought justice for land that had previously been allocated to them and were

not demanding new land. He warned Jupalli Krishna Rao that excessive oppression might lead to rebellion, with Dalit children becoming a strong opposition to the Congress government.

During Minister Jupalli Krishna Rao's site inspection on Tuesday, Dalits Kishtanna, Pentaiah, Balaiah, Balapiru, Sangamiah, and Sesha reported that Raja Jagannath Rao had allocated eight acres of land to them. The minister reportedly threatened the victims and restricted their access, causing further dissatisfaction among the Dalits who are now seeking justice.

## Viral Fever and Dengue Cases Surge in Greater Warangal

**TPN, Warangal:** The Greater Warangal area is witnessing a significant rise in viral fever and dengue cases, causing concern among health authorities. Both government and private hospitals have seen a surge in patients reporting symptoms such as cold, cough, throat pain, body pain, and high fever.

At the Mahatma Gandhi Memorial (MGM) Hospital in Warangal, the daily outpatient (OP) count has reached between 500 and 800, with 30-40 percent of patients presenting with viral fever. Health officials have reported 128 dengue cases and one malaria case in Greater Warangal, but sources suggest that actual dengue cases have likely surpassed 300, as many go unreported. The malaria case was recorded in the Desaipet area of the city.

The situation is particularly severe among

children, with over 250 arriving daily at MGM Hospital with complaints of seasonal fever. More than 50 children are being hospitalized daily, and 60 have been diagnosed with dengue this month alone. The hospital, which has only 150 beds for children, is struggling to accommodate the growing number of patients, often placing two children on a single bed, leading to overcrowding and discomfort.

The rising demand for tests for dengue and other vector-borne diseases has led to long queues at the OPDs and pathology sections of government hospitals, while private labs are also overwhelmed with people seeking tests. Both government and private hospitals in the city are nearly full, with elderly people, children, and women being the most affected by the ongoing viral fever and dengue outbreak.



## Revanth Reddy and KTR to Share Stage at Yechury Memorial Meeting



**TPN, Telangana:** Chief Minister Revanth Reddy and BRS Working President K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) are set to share the same stage at the memorial meeting for late CPM National General Secretary Sitaram Yechury. The event will take place on the 21<sup>st</sup> of this month at Sundarayya Science Center in Hyderabad. This antic-

ipated encounter has sparked interest in political circles, as many are eager to see how the two leaders will interact.

Since the formation of the Congress government in Telangana, tensions between the ruling Congress and the BRS have been high. KTR, in particular, has

frequently criticized the Congress for its failure to implement its promises, including the much-publicized Six Guarantees. His criticism of CM Revanth Reddy has been persistent, often using platforms like Twitter to express his views.

The verbal sparring between Revanth Reddy and KTR has been intense, with both leaders engaging in back-and-forth exchanges on various issues, including the installation of Rajiv Gandhi statues. Given this context, the upcoming meeting between the two leaders has piqued the interest of not only political observers but also the general public.

The memorial meeting, organized by the CPM to honor Yechury, who recently passed away due to illness, will bring both leaders together. Despite their political differences, it is reported that both Revanth Reddy and KTR will attend the event.

## Congress Using Diversion Tactics, Alleges BJP's Laxman



**TPN, Hyderabad:** Senior BJP leader and Rajya Sabha member K. Laxman has accused the Congress government in Telangana of failing to deliver on its promises and using diversion tactics to delay the implementation of the Six Guarantees it made to the people. Speaking at a press conference on Wednesday, Laxman criticized the Congress for its inaction after ten months in power.

"The Congress came to power by making several promises to the people of Telangana, but it has completely failed to fulfill them. Instead, they are trying to divert attention from their failures," Laxman alleged.

He further emphasized that the Congress government appears to have no intention of keeping its promises. Laxman specifically pointed to the Rythu Bandhu scheme, saying that while the BJP government at the Centre has provided substantial financial support to farmers, the Congress government in Telangana has yet to take similar steps.

"As part of the Prime Minister Kisan Nidhi, Rs 20,000 crore was deposited into the accounts of 9.3 crore farmers in the country, including Telangana. Meanwhile, the Congress government has not initiated payments under the Rythu Bandhu scheme," he stated.

Laxman's comments come at a time when the Congress government is under increasing pressure to deliver on its election commitments to the people of Telangana.

## Minister Komatireddy Slams KTR, Promises Development for Nalgonda

**TPN, Nalgonda:** During a gathering at the Miryalaguda MLA camp office, Minister Komatireddy Venkatarreddy made strong remarks, reiterating the Congress party's commitment to fulfilling its pre-election promises under the leadership of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy. Venkatarreddy promised focused development for Nalgonda.

He took aim at BRS leader K.T. Rama Rao (KTR), calling him a "brat" and accusing him of irrational behavior, possibly due to illness. Venkatarreddy also alleged that the previous BRS government engaged in widespread corruption, misappropriating thousands of crores under the guise of development. He contrasted the decades-old Nagarjunasagar project with the current Kaleshwaram project, claiming the latter is an example of BRS corruption.

Regarding the controversial demolition of the district BRS office, Venkatarreddy stated that the courts are handling the issue, respecting the High Court's decision. He also promised to expedite the construction of the Yadadri Thermal Power Plant, which he blamed the previous government for neglecting.

In addition to criticizing former MLA Bhaskara Rao for the lack of development in the constituency, Venkatarreddy questioned KCR's ten-year absence from the secretariat and called for a public release of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's political history.

## Bandi Sanjay Criticizes Congress, BRS for Not Celebrating Telangana Liberation Day

**TPN, Hyderabad:** Union Minister of State for Home Bandi Sanjay Kumar criticized both the Congress and BRS governments for failing to celebrate Telangana Liberation Day, alleging that their reluctance stems from a fear of AIMIM. He expressed his concerns during the inauguration of a photo exhibition organized by the Central Bureau of Communication on Wednesday.

Bandi emphasized that it was the government's responsibility to educate the younger generation about the history of the state's liberation and the significant events surrounding it. "It is unfortunate that Congress, which claims credit for the creation of a separate Telangana, has not made efforts to inform the public about the struggles for the liberation of the erstwhile Hyderabad State," he said.

He pointed out that while India gained independence on August 15, 1947, Telangana did not achieve freedom on the same day. He stressed the importance of acknowledging this part of history and holding celebrations to honor the state's liberation and those responsible for it.

Bandi's remarks come amid ongoing debates about Telangana's historical liberation and the role of different political parties in acknowledging it.

## CPI National Secretary Narayana Criticizes Green Light for Jamili Elections



**TPN, Telangana:** CPI National Secretary Narayana has expressed strong disapproval of the Union Cabinet's approval for Jamili elections. He argues that the decision to push for these elections is an attempt to distract from the government's failures over the past 100 days. Narayana questioned the rationale behind the move, emphasizing that it serves as a diversion from addressing pressing issues faced by the country.

Narayana criticized the government's strategy, suggesting that instead of addressing the issues that have arisen in the first 100 days of their tenure, the authorities are attempting to shift focus through the Jamili elections. He questioned the necessity of combining elections for five states under the Jamili format, pointing out that this approach seems redundant and politically motivated.

He also warned that the decision to implement Jamili elections could lead to significant opposition from the public. Narayana highlighted that the real concerns and problems should be tackled directly rather than attempting to manage them through political maneuvers. According to him, the focus should be on delivering tangible results and addressing the challenges faced by the people, rather than complicating the electoral process with Jamili elections.

The CPI National Secretary reaffirmed his party's stance against the Jamili elections and called for a more transparent and effective approach to governance.

## Congress Misplaced Credit for BRS Achievements in MSME Development

**TPN, Telangana:** Former Minister Harish Rao has expressed regret over the Congress government's attempt to take credit for the achievements of the BRS administration in the development of Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). Under KCR's leadership, Telangana has set a national benchmark for MSME growth. Despite a general decline in MSMEs across many states, Telangana's proactive policies, such as the Integrated Project Approval System (IPAS), have kept its MSME sector vibrant and robust.



The state has witnessed a remarkable 115 percent increase in investments, distinguishing itself as a leader in the country. Additionally, Telangana achieved a 20 percent growth rate in job creation, with SC and ST women securing 30 percent of the job opportunities created. This steady and substantial progress has established Telangana as a role model for other states looking to boost their MSME sectors.

Harish Rao criticized the Congress government for bragging about these accomplishments while failing to acknowledge their own contributions to MSME development. Instead of focusing

on the successful initiatives of the previous BRS regime, the current administration should concentrate on continuing and enhancing these efforts to support the MSME sector further.

Rao emphasized that it is disappointing to see the Congress government divert attention to past achievements without addressing their own strategies and future plans for MSME development. The focus should remain on building upon the solid foundation laid by the BRS and ensuring sustained growth and support for Telangana's MSMEs.

## "One nation, one election" destroys federalism, says Owaisi

**TPN, Telangana:** Reacting to the decision of the Union Cabinet, the Hyderabad MP said he has consistently opposed "one nation, one election" because it's a solution in search of a problem.

"It destroys federalism and compromises democracy, which are part of the basic structure of the Constitution," Owaisi posted on 'X'. "Multiple elections are not a problem for anyone except Modi and Shah. Just because they have a compulsive need to campaign in even municipal and local body elections does not mean that we need simultaneous polls," wrote Owaisi.

The All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) president believes that frequent and periodic elections improve democratic accountability. The Union Cabinet on Wednesday cleared the proposal to hold simultaneous elections in the country, as recommended by a high-level committee headed by former President Ram Nath Kovind.

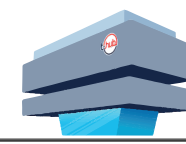
The Kovind committee submitted its report to the government in March, shortly

before the announcement of the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. The committee recommended that the government take a one-time transitory measure, requiring the Union government to identify an appointed date immediately after a Lok Sabha election.



All state assemblies that go to polls after the said date would have their terms expire with the Parliament. After the government constituted the committee in September last year, Owaisi warned that "one nation, one election" would be a disaster for multiparty parliamentary democracy and federalism.

"It is clear this is just a formality, and the government has already decided to go ahead with it. 'One nation, one election' will be a disaster for multiparty parliamentary democracy and federalism," he had said. Owaisi termed the concept of "one nation, one election" as unconstitutional.



## Gandhi Hospital Records Alarming Rise in Maternal and Infant Mortality in August



**TPN, Hyderabad:** In a concerning development, Hyderabad's Gandhi Hospital reported a significant increase in maternal and infant mortality rates in August. A total of 14 mothers and 44 infants lost their lives at the facility, raising serious concerns over the quality of care provided.

Between August 5 and August 30, 14 mothers died due to delivery-related complications, with all the deceased women hailing from various districts in Telangana. During the same period, 44 infants, including one from Andhra Pradesh and the rest from Telangana, died at the hospital's Mother and Child Health (MCH) facility.

Health experts have pointed to the lack of experienced medical staff as a major contributing factor. A recent transfer of 40% of the hospital staff to other healthcare facilities is believed to have affected the quality of care. Doctors have highlighted that MCH facilities require specialized personnel, and the influx of less experienced staff has compromised patient safety.

BRS working president KT Rama Rao expressed his shock on X (formerly Twitter), calling for an immediate investigation into the alarming number of fatalities. He emphasized that Telangana had made remarkable progress in reducing infant and maternal mortality until 2023, and this recent spike is a severe setback.

"This negligence must be thoroughly investigated, and corrective measures should be taken to restore the high standards Telangana has maintained in healthcare," Rao stated in his post, demanding swift action from the Chief Secretary.

The incident has prompted widespread concern over the state of maternal and child healthcare in Telangana, with calls for urgent reforms to prevent further tragedies.

## Hyderabad CP C.V. Anand Reports Peaceful Ganesh Idol Immersion

**TPN, Hyderabad:** City Police Commissioner C.V. Anand announced that the final Ganesh idol immersion procession in Hyderabad concluded peacefully, with no major incidents reported. He noted that this year's immersion process was completed earlier than in previous years, allowing roads to reopen for traffic sooner. "By 10:30 am, all junctions and roads were opened, and the process was completed three hours earlier compared to last year," Anand said.

The CP explained that while the police had planned for the immersion to be completed by 6 or 7 am, some delays occurred due to



non-cooperation from a few pandal organizers, vehicle breakdowns, and power cables obstructing tall idols. He assured that the police would work with organizers in the future to ensure smoother cooperation.

During the ten-day festival, around 1 lakh idols were immersed in Hussainsagar, with 15,000 idols immersed on the final day. To manage the event, a large police force of 25,000 personnel, including 15,000 from the city, was deployed to ensure the safety and smooth conduct of the immersion.

Anand expressed gratitude to the Khairatabad Ganesh Utsav Committee for their cooperation, ensuring that the immersion of the giant Ganesh idol took place by 1:30 pm on Tuesday. He also thanked other government departments for their support in the successful management of the event.

## South Central Railways Announces 48 Special Trains Ahead of Dussehra



**TPN, Hyderabad:** The South Central Railways (SCR) will operate 48 special train services from October 11 to December 2 to accommodate the increased travel demand for the upcoming Dussehra, Deepawali, and Chatt festivals.

Train No. 07625 Nanded-Panvel will run every Monday and Wednesday between October 21 and November 27, while Train No. 07626 Panvel-Nanded will operate every Tuesday and Thursday from October 22 to November 28. Train No. 06071 Kochuveli-Nizamuddin will run every Friday from October 11 to October 29, and Train No. 06072 Nizamuddin-Kochuveli will run every Monday from October 14 to December 2. Additionally, Train No. 01451 Pune-Karimnagar will operate every Monday between October 21 and November 11, and Train No. 01452 Karimnagar-Pune will run every Wednesday from October 23 to November 13.

## 188 IPS Probationers to Pass Out from SVPNA During Dikshant Parade

**TPN, Hyderabad:** On Friday, 188 IPS probationers, along with 19 foreign officers from Nepal, Bhutan, Maldives, and Mauritius, will graduate from the Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Police Academy (SVPNA) during the Dikshant Parade.

Nityanand Rai, Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, will be the Chief Guest for the event. Among the 207 probationers, 58 are women who completed the training alongside their male counterparts.

The first phase of the 45-week training covered various topics, including newly introduced laws such as the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam; investigation, criminology, police management in India; attitudes, ethics, and human rights; internal security; public order; and forensics. Outdoor subjects included physical fitness, weapon training and firing, yoga, unarmed combat, field craft, tactics, and map reading.

SVPNA Director Amit Garg stated that the probationers received specialized training with agencies such as Grey Hounds for jungle survival, ITBP for rock climbing, the Central School of Weapons and Tactics of BSF for advanced weapons training, and attachments with the Indian Army in Jammu and Kashmir, CRPF for LWE counter-training, National Forensic Science University (NFSU), and IIM Ahmedabad.

The probationers were also trained in internal security challenges, threats from drones, cyber-crimes, drug trafficking, cryptocurrency, financial frauds, the dark net, and artificial intelligence. They will now undergo 29 weeks of district practical training before returning to the academy for the second phase of their basic course training, which will last nine weeks.

## Hyderabad Real Estate Is Buying or Renting a Better Option?

**TPN, Hyderabad:** The debate between buying and renting a home in Hyderabad has intensified as rental values continue to surge in the city's key micro-markets. According to Anarock Research, rental values in Hyderabad have risen significantly between the end of 2021 and H1 2024, with areas like Gachibowli and Hitec City experiencing substantial hikes.

Gachibowli's rental values increased by 50%, while capital values

surged by 70%. In Hitec City, rents rose by 46%, with capital values appreciating by 59%. This trend has led many to weigh the benefits of buying versus renting.

Dr. Prashant Thakur, Regional Director & Head of Research at Anarock Group, explained that in other major cities like Bengaluru, Pune, and Chennai, rental values have grown more than property prices. However, in Hyderabad, the

opposite is true, where capital values have outpaced rental increases. This suggests that in areas where capital appreciation is higher, purchasing property might be more beneficial in the long run.

For instance, the average monthly rent in Hitec City rose from Rs 23,000 in 2021 to Rs 33,500 in 2024, while capital values increased from Rs 5,800 to Rs 9,200 per square foot during the same period. Similarly,

Gachibowli rents went up from Rs 22,000 to Rs 33,000, while capital values grew from Rs 5,010 to Rs 8,500 per square foot.

For those considering a long-term investment, purchasing property in these areas may prove more advantageous, given the significant capital appreciation. On the other hand, renters should brace for continued rental hikes in these high-demand areas.

# Hezbollah Pager Attacks: A New Twist in the Gaza Crisis

In a covert operation that feels ripped from a spy thriller, a series of explosive "pager attacks" has added a new and dangerous dimension to the ongoing Gaza crisis. The sophisticated operation, allegedly carried out by Israeli agencies, targeted Hezbollah members, resulting in the deaths of nine individuals and injuries to over 2,700 civilians and fighters. Even Iran's ambassador to Lebanon, Mojtaba Amani, was injured in the explosions.

According to reports, Israeli intelligence intercepted Hezbollah's supply of pagers, a low-tech communication method the group still uses, and laced over 5,000 devices with explosives. The Taiwanese company, Gold Apollo, which allegedly provided the devices, has denied any involvement in the attack.

Though Israel has not officially claimed responsibility, the attack appears to be more than a tactical operation—it's a psychological strike. Israel and Hezbollah have engaged in a clandestine and complex conflict for years, carefully avoiding full-scale war. The pager attack represents another layer of this covert struggle, demonstrating Israel's ability to infiltrate Hezbollah's infrastructure.

Similar Israeli operations in the past, such as the 2021 assassination of Iranian scientist Mohsen Fakhrizadeh and the recent killing of Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran, underscore a broader pattern. These operations aim not just at physical targets but at displaying Israel's ability to strike anywhere, anytime, further destabilizing its opponents' morale and infrastructure.

The attack comes at a time when Hezbollah faces difficult choices. Despite its strength and backing from Iran, the group has largely stayed out of the direct conflict with Israel following the October 2023 Hamas-led attack. This restraint likely stems from two strategic considerations.

First, engaging in a direct conflict in northern Israel would almost certainly trigger a massive Israeli and possibly U.S. military response, leading to heavy casualties and destruction in Lebanon.

Hezbollah, as the dominant political and military force in Lebanon, would be held accountable for such losses.

Second, it is uncertain how far Iran, a crucial Hezbollah ally, would go to support the group in an open conflict. Tehran has yet to respond directly to recent Israeli operations, including the killing of senior Hamas leader Haniyeh. This raises questions about Iran's willingness to commit resources and military support to an all-out war, especially given its focus on maintaining regional stability and avoiding direct confrontation with the U.S.

Hezbollah's cautious approach seems aimed at prolonging the conflict in a way that keeps pressure on Israel without crossing the line into full-scale war. By focusing on small-scale operations and psychological warfare, Hezbollah can create disruptions in northern Israel without risking a catastrophic response.

Yet, even these tactical exchanges carry risks. The rising tensions between Hezbollah and Israel threaten ongoing diplomatic efforts to broker a ceasefire in Gaza, largely led by the U.S. Israeli hostages remain in Hamas custody, and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has made it clear that military operations will continue until Hamas is destroyed. In this volatile environment, any miscalculation could easily escalate into a broader regional conflict.

The pager attack represents more than just a hit on Hezbollah's physical resources—it's a symbolic victory. By targeting a "low-tech" communication system, Israel has disrupted Hezbollah's ability to coordinate forces and has sown doubt within its ranks about the security of its communications. In the short term, this serves as a significant psychological blow.

For Israel, securing psychological victories against its adversaries can be as important as tactical gains. The ability to penetrate Hezbollah's communications and infrastructure reinforces the notion that Israel remains a step ahead, capable of striking whenever it chooses.



## DMK's Son-Rise: Udhayanidhi Stalin Plays Down Deputy CM Rumors

Chennai: Udhayanidhi Stalin, son of Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin and the state's Sports Minister, is rumored to be in line for promotion to the post of Deputy Chief Minister. However, no official announcement has been made, despite widespread speculation. Sources suggest consultations are underway within the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) party, with a formal notification expected from Governor RN Ravi's office.

Speculation about Udhayanidhi's rise within the DMK has been circulating for months. In August, senior party sources indicated that the move was being considered to prepare the party for the 2026 Assembly election and strengthen its second-tier leadership. Udhayanidhi played a crucial role in leading the party's successful campaign in the April-June Lok Sabha election, where the DMK-led alliance won all 39 seats in Tamil Nadu.

This isn't his first significant political contribution. Udhayanidhi also had a hand in the DMK's victories in the 2019 Lok Sabha election and the 2021 Assembly election, which saw the party secure 133 out of 234 seats. His efforts helped the DMK oust the All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (AIADMK) and its ally, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), from power.

Despite his growing presence, Udhayanidhi has been downplaying speculation about his promotion. Speaking to reporters, he stated, "Only the Chief Minister can take that decision," though he acknowledged that some party leaders have expressed their support for his elevation. Party insiders believe Udhayanidhi's potential promotion is also a strategic move to counter the recent political entry of popular Tamil actor Vijay. Known as 'Thalapathy' (commander) to his fans, Vijay launched the Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam party last month, marking his foray into Tamil Nadu politics. Vijay's immense popularity and influence over younger voters pose a potential challenge to the DMK in future elections.

The timing of Udhayanidhi's rise, therefore, is being seen as a way to consolidate the DMK's leadership ahead of the 2026 elections and to present a youthful face to the electorate, in contrast to the new political aspirations of Vijay. Predictably, Udhayanidhi Stalin's possible elevation has sparked criticism from opposition parties, particularly the AIADMK. The opposition has accused the DMK of engaging in

dynastic politics, drawing parallels between Udhayanidhi's rise and the political legacy of his grandfather, the late M. Karunanidhi. AIADMK spokesperson Kovai Sathyan claimed that Udhayanidhi's promotion "would signal the end of the DMK" and suggested that the party would split before the 2026 election.

Sathyan also recalled that before the 2021 election, Chief Minister MK Stalin had assured the public that neither his son nor his son-in-law, Sabareesan (who is married to MK Stalin's daughter Senthamarai), would enter politics. However, DMK sources have brushed off these criticisms, arguing that Udhayanidhi was "democratically elected" as an MLA and therefore cannot be accused of inheriting his political role without merit.

The BJP has also been critical of Udhayanidhi, particularly in light of his controversial remarks about eradicating 'Sanatan Dharma' last year, for which he still faces legal action. The party has used these remarks to question his leadership potential and his ability to handle delicate political matters.

Fueling the speculation further, Tamil Nadu Welfare Minister Raja Kannappan recently referred to Udhayanidhi as the Deputy Chief Minister during a public event. Although Kannappan quickly corrected himself, his slip suggested that Udhayanidhi's promotion may be imminent.

When asked about the rumors of his son's promotion, MK Stalin acknowledged that the demand for Udhayanidhi's elevation within the party had grown but indicated that the timing was not yet right. He remarked that the situation "has not ripened" yet.

A first-time MLA representing the Chepauk-Thiruvallikeni constituency, Udhayanidhi Stalin also serves as the Secretary of the DMK's Youth Wing. He has been credited with rejuvenating the party, particularly through the enrollment of large numbers of young people. His potential elevation to Deputy Chief Minister could signal the DMK's focus on solidifying its leadership transition ahead of future elections.

While speculation continues to swirl around his political future, Udhayanidhi has made it clear that any decision regarding his promotion lies solely with his father, the Chief Minister. As of now, the Tamil Nadu political landscape remains in a state of anticipation, awaiting the next move from the DMK leadership.



## Centre Launches Fast-Track Immigration Programme for Seamless Airport Experience

The Centre has introduced a Fast Track Immigration Trusted Traveller Programme (FTI-TTP) to streamline the immigration process at airports, drastically reducing clearance time from an average of 30 minutes to just seconds. Launched at Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport on June 22, the programme utilizes biometric data to provide pre-verified passengers with a seamless immigration experience for both departures and arrivals.

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) is spearheading this initiative, which has already proven successful in Delhi, with 18,400 Indian passport holders and Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholders registered. The programme is now being expanded

to major airports, including Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Cochin, and Ahmedabad. In total, the FTI-TTP will be implemented at 21 airports across India.

A senior MHA official described the programme as a game-changer for international travel from India. "Eligible passengers can bypass regular immigration queues by utilizing automated e-gates, ensuring a faster, smoother, and more secure immigration process," the official said.

### How It Works

The FTI-TTP system operates through an online portal managed by the Bureau of Immigration, which acts as the nodal agency. Once passengers apply

and undergo necessary verifications, they are added to a 'Trusted Traveller' White List. Biometrics, including fingerprints and facial recognition, are captured at airports or Foreigners Regional Registration Offices.

When the registered travellers reach an e-gate, they scan their boarding pass, passport, and biometrics for authentication. Once the identity is confirmed, the e-gate opens, and immigration clearance is granted automatically, allowing passengers to bypass traditional immigration queues.

### How To Apply

Eligible individuals, including Indian citizens and OCI cardholders, must apply online at [www.ftittp.mha.gov.

in](http://www.ftittp.mha.gov.in). After submitting the necessary details, the Bureau of Immigration verifies the information and schedules a biometric appointment at international airports or nearby Foreigners Regional Registration Offices.

The FTI-TTP registration is valid for up to five years or until the passport expires, whichever comes first. Applicants are required to have a passport with at least six months' validity and must provide their biometrics to complete the registration process.

### Expansion and Future Phases

Currently, the programme is in its first phase, covering Indian citizens and OCI cardholders. In the second

phase, it will expand to include foreign nationals. By automating the immigration process, the FTI-TTP aims to minimize human intervention and create a more efficient, secure system for international travellers.

Officials also provided a helpdesk email (india.ftittp-boi@mha.gov.in) for queries and assistance related to the programme. The FTI-TTP marks a significant step in modernizing India's immigration system, promising quicker and more efficient travel for frequent flyers and international visitors. As the programme expands to more airports, it is expected to enhance India's reputation as a global travel hub by making the immigration process faster and more convenient for all eligible travellers.

# PM Modi On "One Nation One Election" Plan

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today commended the cabinet's decision to approve the Kovind panel's proposal for "One Nation, One Election." In a post on X (formerly Twitter), he expressed gratitude to former President Ram Nath Kovind for leading this initiative and engaging various stakeholders. Modi remarked, "The Cabinet has accepted the recommendations of the High-Level Committee on Simultaneous Elections. This is an important step towards making our democracy even more vibrant and participative."

The proposal originates from the report of the committee chaired by Kovind, advocating for simultaneous Lok Sabha and Assembly elections. Additionally, the plan suggests that urban body and panchayat elections should occur within 100 days of the general and state elections.

PM Modi has consistently championed the "One Nation, One Election" concept, asserting that it is essential for the country's governance. He has highlighted the disruptions caused by staggered elections, stating, "Elections are held at different places every few months. The effect it has on development work is known to all." This sentiment is echoed by several Supreme Court judges, who have noted the potential resource savings associated



with simultaneous elections.

The Kovind panel's report outlines multiple benefits of conducting elections concurrently. It argues that this approach would "optimise scarce resources" and contribute to a more stable economy. By consolidating elections, businesses would be better positioned to make strategic decisions without the uncertainty of frequent policy changes, the report noted.

The backing of the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) and support from judicial figures suggest a growing consensus around the feasibility and advantages of this proposal. As discussions continue, the implementation of "One Nation, One Election" could significantly reshape the electoral landscape in India, fostering more efficient governance and a more engaged electorate.

## Union Minister Says His Party Did Not Get Place In Maharashtra Cabinet Due To Ajit Pawar

Union Minister Ramdas Athawale has claimed that his party, the Republican Party of India (Athawale) [RPI (A)], did not receive a promised ministerial berth in the Maharashtra cabinet due to the inclusion of Ajit Pawar's Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) in the Mahayuti government. Speaking to reporters in Dahanu on Tuesday, Athawale expressed disappointment that the RPI (A) was denied cabinet positions, as well as leadership roles in two corporations and district-level committees, following Ajit Pawar's alliance with the ruling coalition in July 2022.

Athawale also stated that his party should be allotted 12 seats to contest in the upcoming Maharashtra assembly elections and given representation in the state cabinet. He expressed confidence that the ruling Mahayuti alliance would secure 150 to 160 seats in the 288-member assembly.

On the issue of Maratha reservation, Athawale suggested a separate category for Marathas rather than including them under the Other Backward Classes (OBC) category to avoid opposition from OBC groups. He urged the Maharashtra government to study Tamil Nadu's reservation system and recommended that economically weaker Marathas earning less than ₹8 lakh annually be provided with reservation.

Athawale also voiced his support for the Waqf (Amendment) Bill, 2024, and highlighted the achievements of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, noting that its initiatives benefit 45% of India's population. He cited the ministry's de-addiction campaign and financial inclusion schemes like Mudra Yojana and Ujjwala Gas Yojana, which have provided benefits to 46 crore individuals and opened 51 crore bank accounts.

# Yogi Adityanath Targets Rahul Gandhi, Akhilesh Yadav

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath employed shayari to target the Opposition, specifically the Samajwadi Party and the Congress, labeling them "Bhasmasur" for allegedly misusing their power to suppress the populace. Speaking at an event in Ghaziabad, he reflected on the past, saying, "When the Congress was in power at the Centre before 2014 and the Samajwadi Party in Uttar Pradesh before 2017, their actions speak volumes. They may make tall claims now, but if you look at their dark deeds, the reality is evident."

Adityanath recited lines that resonate with his critique: "Nazar nahin hai, nazaron ki baat karte hain, zameen par chand-sitaron ki baat karte hain, woh haath jodkar basti ko lutne wale, bhari sabha mein sudharon ki baat karte hain." This translates to accusing the opposition of being blind to their own failures while making lofty promises and pretending to seek reform.

Specifically targeting Samajwadi Party chief Akhilesh Yadav and Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, Adityanath stated that they have come to Uttar Pradesh solely to mislead the public. "They have only looted and done good for no one except their families. When given power, they have misused it like Bhasmasur," he claimed.

alleged misuse of authority by these leaders. Adityanath accused the previous Congress government of enacting laws that suppressed Hindus, while asserting that the Samajwadi Party supported such actions.

The Chief Minister further criticized the Samajwadi Party for allegedly aligning



with criminals during its rule, quipping, "Aurangzeb's soul has entered them." In response to Yadav's comparison of religious leaders to mafia members, Adityanath highlighted the safety and progress of Hindus under his governance, stating, "Today, daughters are safe, traders are respected, youth have jobs, and farmers are thriving."

This exchange comes amid ongoing criticism from the Samajwadi Party regarding the law and order situation in the state.



## Centre Must Clarify 'One Nation, One Election' Implementation: KTR

Bharat Rashtra Samiti (BRS) Working President K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) called on the Central Government to clarify how it plans to implement the 'One Nation, One Election' proposal. He emphasized that key issues such as conducting a census, delimitation of constituencies, and implementing women's reservation need to be addressed before the 2029 general elections.

Responding to questions from the media about the party's stance on simultaneous polls, KTR stated, "The central government needs to clarify how they plan to implement this. Parliament elections recently concluded, and the next Lok Sabha elections are scheduled for 2029."

KTR raised concerns over whether the Centre plans to abolish state governments before 2029 and hold simultaneous elections or if the plan will be implemented in phases. He stressed that the BRS will be able to take a clear position only after the Centre provides more details.

The Union Cabinet recently approved the 'One Nation, One Election' proposal, as recommended by a panel led by former President Ram Nath Kovind, sparking debates across political circles.

## Nirmala Sitharaman Launches NPS Vatsalya Scheme



Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched the NPS Vatsalya scheme on Tuesday, designed to help parents save for their children's futures through a pension account. This new initiative allows parents to subscribe online or visit their local bank or post office, with a minimum initial contribution of ₹1,000. Following this, subscribers are required to contribute ₹1,000 annually.

During the launch, Sitharaman emphasized that the National Pension System (NPS) has provided competitive returns while offering individuals a way to save for future income. The NPS Vatsalya scheme builds upon the existing NPS, which has attracted 1.86 crore subscribers over the past decade, amassing an Asset Under Management (AUM) of ₹13 lakh crore.

The scheme is open to children below 18 years of age, and accounts will automatically convert to regular NPS accounts upon reaching adulthood. However, pension payouts will commence only after the

account holder turns 60.

Sitharaman highlighted the impressive returns generated by NPS investments, noting that equity investments have yielded returns of 14%, while corporate debt and government securities have generated 9.1% and 8.8% returns, respectively. The NPS Vatsalya scheme was first announced in the FY25 Budget presented in July.

Major banks, including ICICI Bank and Axis Bank, have partnered with the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) to promote NPS Vatsalya. ICICI Bank recently inaugurated the scheme in Mumbai, registering several children's accounts to kick off its implementation.

Financial Services Secretary Nagaraju Maddirala assured that the government values subscriber feedback and is committed to refining the pension scheme.

# Donald Trump Will Meet PM Modi Next Week

Former US President Donald Trump announced on Tuesday that he will meet Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his upcoming visit to the United States. Trump made this revelation while campaigning in Michigan, describing Modi as a "fantastic man" but simultaneously labeling India as a "very big abuser" of trade relations.

During his remarks, Trump highlighted India's high tariffs on imports, stating, "So when India, which is a very big abuser, he (Modi) happens to be coming to meet me next week." Despite his criticism, Trump expressed admiration for Modi and other global leaders, calling them "fantastic."

The meeting will take place as Modi

visits the US from September 21 to 23, where he is scheduled to participate in several significant events, including the fourth Quad Leaders' Summit hosted by President Joe Biden in Wilmington, Delaware. Modi will also address the 'Summit of the Future' at the United Nations General Assembly in New York, which focuses on "Multilateral Solutions for a Better Tomorrow."

In addition to these engagements, Modi plans to connect with the Indian community during a gathering in Long Island. He will also meet with CEOs of prominent US-based companies to discuss collaborations in advanced fields such as artificial intelligence, quantum computing, semiconductors, and biotechnology, according to the foreign

ministry.

This upcoming meeting will mark the first time Modi and Trump have interacted since their last meeting in February 2020 when Trump visited India. Modi characterized that encounter as a "path-breaking" moment for strengthening India-US relations.

As Modi prepares for this visit, the discussions are likely to address not only trade issues but also broader geopolitical concerns, reflecting the ongoing importance of the India-US partnership on the global stage. The dynamics of this relationship will be further examined during their meeting, especially in light of Trump's critical remarks on trade practices.



## India's Major Space Push: Approval for Venus, Moon, and Space Station Missions

The Union Cabinet has approved a significant investment of ₹31,772 crores for various space missions, setting the roadmap for the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) until nearly 2040. Key projects include the Chandrayaan-4 mission, a mission to Venus, enhancements to the Gaganyaan program with the Bharatiya Antariksh Station (BAS), and the development of a new rocket named Soorya.

ISRO Chairman Dr. Somanath expressed enthusiasm over these approvals, stating, "India's ambitious space vision and roadmap have now been given the wings to fly high." The approvals come within 100 days of the new government taking office, marking a proactive step in advancing India's space capabilities.

The Chandrayaan-4 mission aims to demonstrate technologies for safely returning to Earth after a lunar landing, including sample collection and analysis. This multi-stage mission has been allocated ₹2,104 crores and is expected to be completed within 36 months, laying the groundwork for a planned Indian moon landing by 2040.

In a continuation of its planetary exploration efforts, ISRO will also develop the Venus Orbiter Mission (VOM), building on the success of its Mars mission in 2013. With a budget of ₹1,236 crores, VOM aims to study Venus' surface and atmospheric processes, launching in March 2028.

The cabinet also approved the first unit of the Bharatiya Antariksh Station (BAS-1) as part of the Gaganyaan program. This initiative will enhance India's human spaceflight capabilities, with ₹20,193 crores allocated to the Gaganyaan and BAS missions, targeting completion by December 2029.

To support these ambitious goals, the cabinet has greenlit the development of the Next Generation Launch Vehicle (NGLV), named Soorya. With a budget of ₹8,239 crores, Soorya will significantly increase payload capacity and reusability, crucial for future missions, including potential crewed lunar landings by 2040.

This comprehensive approval signals India's commitment to leveraging space technology for national development and global leadership in space exploration.

## Joe Biden's Five-Decade Political Career

Joseph Robinette Biden Jr., the 46th President of the United States, has navigated a remarkable political journey spanning over five decades. His ascent to the White House at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue has been marked by personal hardships, political victories, and a steadfast commitment to public service.

Born on November 20, 1942, in Scranton, Pennsylvania, Biden grew up in a working-class family that faced financial struggles. His father, Joseph Sr., worked as a car salesman after his initial business failed, while his mother, Catherine, instilled strong moral values in him. The family later relocated to Claymont, Delaware, where Biden attended Archmere Academy and developed leadership skills. He graduated from the University of Delaware in 1965 with degrees in history and political science and earned a law degree from Syracuse University in 1968.

Biden's personal life has been marked by tragedy. He married Neilia Hunter in 1966, and they had three children: Beau, Hunter, and Naomi. In 1972, shortly after Biden was elected to the Senate, a car accident claimed the lives of Neilia and Naomi. Biden contemplated resigning to care for his surviving sons but chose to continue his political career.

In 1977, he married Jill Jacobs, an educator, and they have a daughter, Ashley. Biden faced another profound loss when Beau, who served as



Delaware's attorney general, died from brain cancer in 2015. Beau's legacy significantly influenced Biden's decision to run for president.

Biden entered politics shortly after law school, winning a Senate seat in 1972 at age 30, making him one of the youngest senators in U.S. history. Over his tenure, he focused on foreign policy, criminal justice, and drug policy. He chaired both the Senate Judiciary Committee and the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, playing a vital role in shaping U.S. policies, including the 1994 Crime Bill.

In 2008, Biden became Barack Obama's running

mate, contributing to the administration's efforts during the financial crisis and in passing the Affordable Care Act.

Biden's road to the presidency was challenging, with previous runs in 1988 and 2008 ending unsuccessfully. He entered the 2020 race as a moderate candidate and secured the Democratic nomination amid a tumultuous political climate characterized by a pandemic and social unrest.

Biden focused on unity and systemic change, selecting Kamala Harris as his running mate—marking a historic milestone as the first woman and first woman of color in the role. He won the election on November 7, 2020, with 306 electoral votes, despite facing challenges to the results.

At 78, Biden became the oldest president in U.S. history. While his age raised concerns regarding his cognitive abilities, he remained committed to his agenda, including significant legislative efforts.

Biden's presidency has been defined by his response to the COVID-19 pandemic and economic recovery. His administration passed the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan, providing essential relief to millions. ## Ukrainian Drone Attack Triggers Massive Explosion at Russian Arsenal

A significant Ukrainian drone strike on a military arsenal in Russia's Tver region caused a massive explosion, described as earthquake-sized, prompting the evacuation of nearby towns. The attack occurred on Wednesday and was reported by war bloggers and various media outlets.

Unverified videos and images on social media captured a large fireball shooting into the sky, accompanied by multiple detonations near a lake approximately 380 km (240 miles) west of Moscow. NASA satellites detected intense heat in an area of about 14 square kilometers (5 square miles), and earthquake sensors recorded what appeared to be a small quake.

Pro-Russian military blogger Yuri Podolyaka confirmed the strike, stating, "The enemy hit an ammunition depot in the area of Toropets," noting that fires and explosions were ongoing. However, Russian state media provided limited coverage, reflecting strict military censorship.

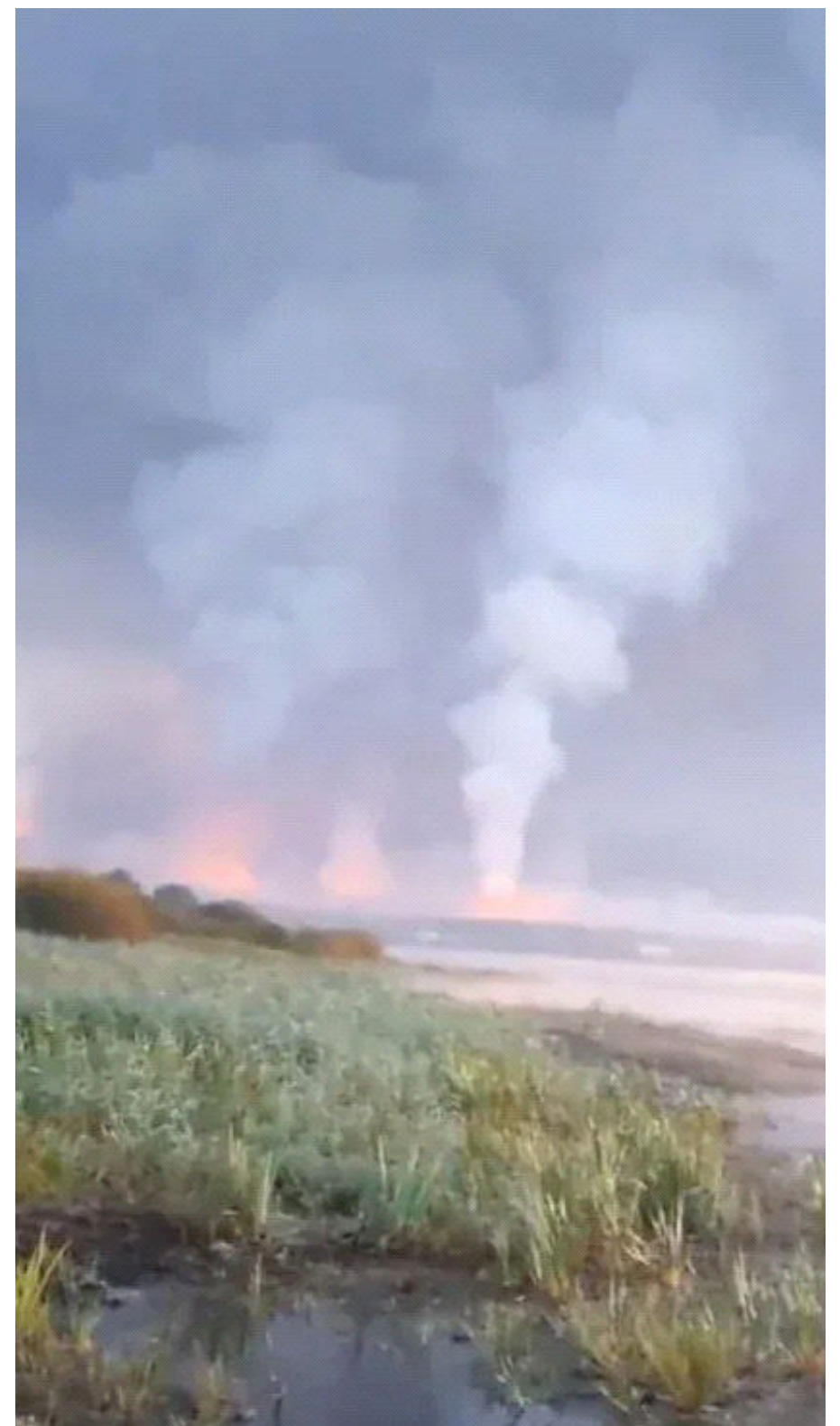
Igor Rudenya, the governor of Tver, reported that Ukrainian drones had been intercepted and that some residents were evacuated, but he did not specify what was burning. Eyewitness Irina mentioned explosions and fires erupting, prompting evacuations from the town of Toropets.

A source within Ukraine's SBU state security service indicated that the drone attack targeted a warehouse containing missiles and artillery ammunition. As of now, there are no confirmed reports of casualties.

The scale of the explosion, as estimated by experts, suggests the detonation of around 200-240 tons of high explosives. Residents in Toropets expressed concern in online forums, with many inquiring about the status of their homes in nearby Kudino, a village severely impacted by the blasts.

Some war bloggers raised questions about how the drones could breach a facility believed to be well-fortified. Reports from 2018 indicated that Russia had been constructing an arsenal in Toropets designed to withstand missile strikes and even small nuclear attacks.

Social media reactions from Russians included frustration over the apparent negligence regarding the ammunition storage. In response to the drone attacks, Russia claimed to have shot down 54 drones across multiple regions, while Ukraine reported downing 46 of 52 drones launched by Russia that night. The ongoing conflict continues to see significant military actions on both sides.

## India's Oil Firms Face \$900 Million Stuck in Russian Dividends



India's public sector oil companies are grappling with a significant financial challenge, as approximately \$900 million in dividend income from their Russian investments remains trapped due to complications in repatriating the funds. The issue stems from a lack of a viable mechanism to transfer this money back to India or utilize it in bilateral trade following the restrictions imposed after Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022.

Companies like ONGC Videsh (OVL), Oil India (OIL), Indian Oil Corporation (IOC), and Bharat Petroleum Corporation's arm Bharat PetroResources (BPRL) are affected, with their dividend payments from Russian upstream oil projects stuck in their Moscow bank accounts. These funds, currently being credited in roubles, have become increasingly difficult to access due to the evolving geopolitical landscape.

The accumulating dividends are primarily held in Commercial Indo Bank Limited (CIBL), an affiliate of the State Bank of India (SBI). As restrictions on payment channels remain in place, the Indian firms have struggled to find an effective solution to repatriate the earnings. This situation not only hampers the financial health of these companies but also affects India's overall energy security and economic relations with Russia.

## RBI Unlikely to Cut Rates in 2024 Amid Food Inflation Concerns

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is not expected to ease the benchmark policy rate in 2024, primarily due to ongoing uncertainties surrounding food inflation, according to State Bank of India (SBI) Chairman C.S. Setty. As central banks worldwide, including the US Federal Reserve, prepare for potential interest rate cuts, Setty emphasizes that the RBI will remain cautious, particularly regarding food price fluctuations.

In a recent interview with PTI, Setty explained that while the Fed's rate cut could influence global monetary policy, the RBI must prioritize domestic factors, specifically food inflation, before making any decisions about lowering interest rates. "Our view is that a rate cut this calendar year may not happen. We may have to wait until the fourth quarter of 2025, unless we see significant improvement in food inflation," he stated.

The RBI's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC), led by Governor Shaktikanta Das, is set to convene from October 7 to 9 to evaluate interest rates. As of now, retail inflation has risen slightly to 3.65% in August, up from 3.54% in July. Although this figure remains below the RBI's target median of 4%, food inflation is concerning, with the food basket experiencing a price increase of 5.66% in August.



## Adani Group Denies Kenyan Report

Adani Group has issued a statement today refuting a report from local Kenyan media suggesting that the company made comments regarding the Kenya Airports Authority and its approval process. The group called the claims "entirely false."



In its statement, dated September 18, Adani Group expressed concern over a report published by \*The Standard (Kenya)\*, stating, "We have come across a report claiming that the Adani Group made a statement regarding the Kenya Airports Authority and the approval process of a proposal. We would like to clarify that this report is entirely false." The company emphasized that it has not made any such statements or engaged with the media on this issue.

Adani Group urged media outlets to confirm information through official channels to prevent the spread of misinformation. The company's statement highlighted its commitment to transparency and accurate reporting.

## SEBI Employees' Demands Met with Regulatory Committee

Employees of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) have received a positive response to their demands for a better work environment and a fair performance-tracking system. According to sources, SEBI has committed to forming a committee, including whole-time members, to address these concerns. This move suggests a resolution may be on the horizon, as SEBI appears to be accommodating some of the employees' requests.

The dispute began escalating when SEBI issued a press statement on September 4, which triggered intensified protests from employees. Following the backlash, SEBI withdrew the controversial statement. Employees had been voicing their grievances for weeks, culminating in silent protests that lasted three days after the statement was released. They specifically requested intervention from SEBI's whole-time members to address their issues.



## Export Growth Shows Promise Amid Rising Imports In India

India's total exports during the April-August 2024 period are estimated at \$328.86 billion, reflecting a robust growth of 5.35%, according to data from the Ministry of Commerce and Industry released on Tuesday. In contrast, total imports for the same period reached approximately \$375.33 billion, showing an increase of 7.20%.

Merchandise exports specifically amounted to \$178.68 billion, compared to \$176.67 billion during the same timeframe last year, marking a modest growth of 1.14%. However, the merchandise trade deficit widened



significantly, reaching \$116.64 billion this year compared to \$99.16 billion last year.

In August alone, India's total exports (including both merchandise and services) reached \$65.40 billion. Of this, merchandise exports were recorded at \$34.71 billion, a decline from \$38.28 billion in August 2023.

Notably, non-petroleum and non-gems and jewellery exports saw growth, totaling \$135.75 billion in the April-August 2024 period, up from \$128.95 billion during the same period last year. Conversely, non-petroleum, non-gems and jewellery imports increased to \$186.25 billion from \$177.13 billion in the previous year.





# CABINET APPROVES 'ONE NATION, ONE ELECTION' PUSH AMID OPPOSITION RESISTANCE



In a significant move towards the implementation of simultaneous elections across India, the Union Cabinet has cleared the government's proposal for the 'One Nation, One Election' initiative. This plan, which seeks to synchronize elections for the Lok Sabha, state assemblies, urban bodies, and panchayats, has garnered widespread debate across the political spectrum.

The proposal, based on the recommendations of a panel headed by former President Ram Nath Kovind, aims to hold simultaneous elections starting from 2029, with a timeline of 100 days for panchayat and urban body polls. The panel also includes prominent figures such as Home Minister Amit Shah and Law Minister Arjun Ram Meghwal, and has proposed provisions for a 'unity government' in cases where elections result in a hung verdict or no-confidence motions are passed.

While the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has strongly backed the initiative, highlighting its inclusion in both the 2019 and 2024 election manifestos, the proposal has faced staunch opposition. Key parties, including the Congress, Samajwadi Party, and Trinamool Congress, have voiced strong concerns over the practicality and constitutional implications of such a move.

## Advantages of 'One Nation, One Election'



Proponents of the simultaneous election system argue that it will overhaul the electoral process and governance in India by optimizing resources and improving voter convenience. The Kovind-led panel noted that 32 political parties and notable judicial figures, including former Chief Justices of the Supreme Court and High Courts, have expressed support for this measure.

The panel outlined several advantages, including a more streamlined electoral process, which it believes will ease the voting experience for the public. Additionally, it argues that the synchronization of elections would lead to faster economic growth by reducing uncertainty caused by frequent elections. With businesses and industries often held back by shifting political policies, the government claims that a unified election schedule would result in greater stability for corporate decision-making and production cycles.

Another key point raised by the panel was the disruption caused by frequent elections. It pointed out that supply chains and production cycles are often affected when migrant workers take leave to return to their home states to cast votes. By aligning elections across the country, this disruption could be minimized.

Furthermore, the government emphasized that simultaneous elections would prevent policy paralysis and eliminate the "atmosphere of uncertainty" brought about by continuous electoral cycles.

## Government's Stance and Roadmap



Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnav confirmed that the government plans to implement 'One Nation, One Election' in a phased manner. A unified voter list will be created, and elections across all levels of government will be synchronized.

Vaishnav noted that initial discussions on the matter have been positive, with 80% of respondents indicating support for the proposal during preliminary consultations. "There is widespread support for this system," he told reporters, emphasizing the government's commitment to moving forward.

Anurag Thakur, a former Union Minister, underscored that India held simultaneous elections prior to 1962 and pointed to the potential savings in resources and deployment of security forces. He stressed that by avoiding multiple elections, India could fast-track its development goals.

sues. "This is not going to succeed... the people will not accept it," Kharge said while releasing the Congress manifesto for the upcoming Haryana elections.

Senior Congress leader P. Chidambaram also voiced his concerns, arguing that the current constitutional framework does not permit simultaneous elections. Chidambaram warned that implementing such a system would require at least five constitutional amendments, which he suggested would be challenging to achieve.

Other opposition leaders have raised concerns about the potential implications of simultaneous elections on regional issues. West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, a fierce critic of the proposal, has characterized it as a threat to the country's democratic structure, stating that it is an attempt to consolidate power and promote autocracy under the guise of democracy.

The Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK), a key player in the opposition-led INDIA alliance, has promised to scrap the proposal if the bloc wins the next general election. Additionally, regional parties have highlighted concerns over limited resources, making it harder to focus on local issues during election campaigns dominated by national agendas.

## Challenges Ahead

One of the major hurdles to implementing 'One Nation, One Election' is the need for significant constitutional amendments. To push the proposal through, the government would require a two-thirds majority in Parliament, as at least six constitutional amendments would be needed to bring the plan to life.

Moreover, the cost of procuring electronic voting machines (EVMs) for a simultaneous election has been flagged as a potential issue. The Election Commission has estimated that the cost of acquiring EVMs could reach ₹10,000 crore every 15 years.



## Opposition Pushback

Despite the government's optimism, opposition parties remain highly critical of the proposal. Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge has been one of the most vocal opponents, dismissing the plan as impractical and accusing the government of attempting to divert public attention from pressing is-

## Food Packaging Chemicals Found In Human Bodies In New Study

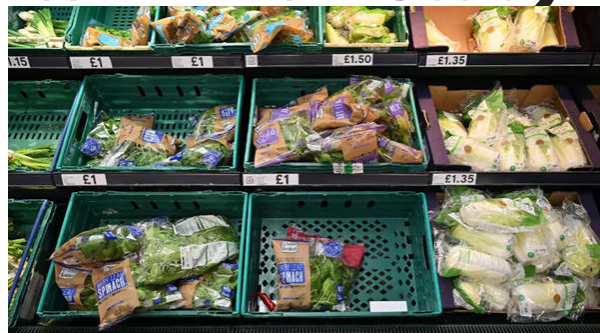
A recent study reveals that over 3,600 chemicals used in food packaging or preparation have been found in human bodies, raising significant health concerns. Led by Birgit Geueke from the Food Packaging Forum Foundation, the research identifies about 100 of these chemicals as "high concern" for human health.

Among the well-known offenders are PFAS and bisphenol A (BPA), both of which have faced bans due to their hazardous effects. However, many of the chemicals detected in this study remain poorly understood in terms of their health implications. Geueke emphasizes the need for further research into how these substances migrate into food.

The researchers previously catalogued around 14,000 food contact chemicals (FCCs) that can migrate from packaging made of materials like plastic, paper, glass, and metal. Additionally, chemicals can originate from other stages in food production, such as conveyor belts and kitchen utensils.

Surprisingly, the study discovered 3,601 FCCs in existing biomonitoring databases, constituting nearly a quarter of all known FCCs. Geueke cautions that the study does not definitively link these chemicals to food packaging, as other exposure sources could be at play.

High-concern chemicals include multiple PFAS, known as "forever chemicals," which



have been detected in various human tissues and are associated with serious health issues. BPA, a hormone-disrupting chemical banned in baby bottles in many countries, was also identified, along with phthalates, linked to infertility. Oligomers, byproducts of plastic production, are particularly concerning due to their unknown health effects.

While the study couldn't determine the concentration levels of these chemicals, Geueke warns about their potential interactions, citing samples with up to 30 different PFAS. To minimize exposure, she recommends reducing contact time with packaging and avoiding heating food in its original containers.

Duane Mellor, an expert in evidence-based medicine, praises the study's thoroughness but notes it does not quantify exposure levels or explore other environmental sources. He advises the public to seek better data and reduce unnecessary chemical exposure. Meanwhile, the European Union is moving towards banning PFAS and BPA in food packaging.

Unlike traditional banking methods that require multiple layers of authentication, UPI transactions can be completed with minimal verification, making it easier for cybercriminals to operate without needing access to banking credentials.

Criminals use various tactics to exploit UPI's convenience. Phishing attacks, for instance, involve deceiving users into providing personal information or access to their accounts. Some scammers even pose as legitimate service providers, tricking individuals into sharing sensitive details that can lead to unauthorized transactions.

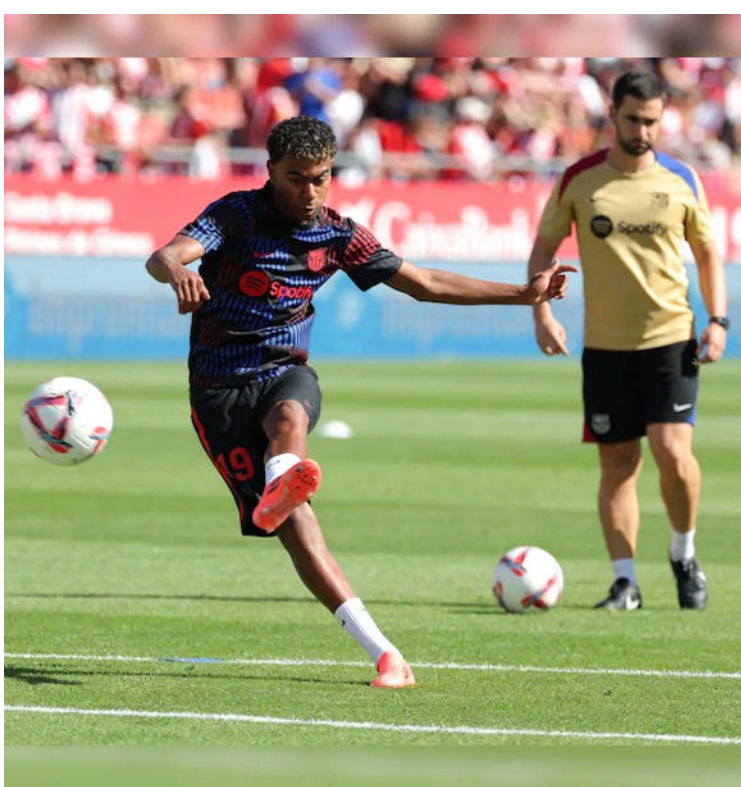
## Lamine Yamal Leads Barcelona's Champions League Ambitions

As Barcelona prepares to face Monaco in their Champions League opener on Thursday, the Catalan giants aim to revive their European glory nearly a decade after their last title. ## Ricky Ponting Appointed Head Coach of Punjab Kings

Australian cricket legend Ricky Ponting has been named the head coach of Punjab Kings, taking over from compatriot Trevor Bayliss. In the past seven seasons, Punjab has failed to finish in the top five and ranked ninth out of ten teams earlier this year.
