



Cyberabad Police Arrest Choreographer Jani Master in Goa

TPN, Hyderabad: The Cyberabad Police arrested popular choreographer Shaik Jani, alias Jani Master, in Goa on Thursday in connection with a case of alleged sexual assault and threats made against an assistant choreographer.

Authorities had been on the lookout for Jani Master after a complaint was filed by the victim, who accused him of multiple instances of sexual assault and intimidation during shooting schedules. The complaint was initially lodged at the Raidurgam police station, where a 'zero FIR' was registered before the case was transferred to the Narsingi police station for jurisdictional

Based on the victim's allegations, the police invoked Sections of the POCSO Act, along with other relevant laws, leading to the choreographer going into hiding. After an intense search, Jani Master was located and taken into custody in Bengaluru.

The victim's complaint claims that Jani Master had repeatedly sexually assaulted and threatened her, exploiting his position of power within the film industry. Further investigation into the case is underway as the police proceed with formal charges.

Electricity Charges Set to Rise Again in Telangana

TPN, Telangana: Steps are being taken to increase electricity cha rges in Telangana. Electricity distribution companies (discoms) have submitted proposals to the Electricity Regulatory Commission (ERC) to revise charges across three categories. If approved, the revised tariffs could help cover a rev enue shortfall of approximately Rs. 1,200 crore, as estimated by the discoms. The final decision will be announced after the ERC con ducts a public hearing on these proposals.

Discoms have reported to the ERC that there is a need to raise charges to compensate for the



financial shortfall. This year, the North and South DISCOMs are projected to face a deficit of Rs. 14,222 crore. Out of this amount, they have requested Rs. 13,022 crore from the state government through the budget. To address the remaining Rs. 1,200 crore shortfall, the discoms have submitted tariff revision proposals.

KTR Condemns Arrest of Farmers Ahead of 'Chalo Praja Bhavan' Protest

TPN, Hyderabad: Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) creating concern and distress among their families. restrictions on farmers?" he asked. The BRS leader working president K. T. Rama Rao (KTR) strongly condemned the arrest of farmers ahead of the 'Chalo Praja Bhavan' protest, which was organized to pressurize the Telangana government to implement its promise of a farm loan waiver. The protest was aimed at demanding the waiver of crop loans up to Rs 2 lakh, a promise made by the Congress-led government during elections.

KTR expressed outrage over the arrest of farmers and leaders of farmers' unions, alleging that they had been illegally detained by the police. "Are they thieves and terrorists?" KTR asked, criticizing the police actions as undemocratic. He stated that since early Thursday, BRS received reports of police visiting farmers' homes and detaining them,

KTR demanded the immediate release of the farmers, questioning why the Chief Minister was so afraid of peaceful protests. "Why are there so many



reiterated that the protest was initiated by farmers themselves and was not politically motivated, asserting that the Congress government would eventually have to concede to the farmers' demands.

The BRS has been vocal about the incomplete implementation of the farm loan waiver, claiming that many farmers were yet to see their loans waived. In contrast, the state government claimed that Rs 18,000 crore had been deposited into the bank accounts of 22 lakh farmers to fulfill the waiver commitment. Chief Minister Revanth Reddy acknowledged the challenges faced in implementing the waiver and assured that every eligible farmer would receive the promised benefit.

Contractors interested in participating in this tender process can submit their applications online. The submission window for these tenders will open on September 20 and will remain open until September 27. This timeline allows interested parties to prepare and submit their proposals for consideration.

HYDRA's efforts are part of a larger strategy to address illegal constructions and promote sustainable development in Hyderabad. By clearing these unauthorized structures and managing the associated waste, HYDRA aims to enhance the city's infrastructure and environmental health. This initiative underscores the agency's commitment to maintaining urban spaces that are both functional and environmentally responsible.

Hydra's Next Target: Lake View Apartments

Hydra is currently investigating the large-scale projects known as "Lake View," which are being constructed near local ponds.

While some companies argue that they have not encroached upon the pond areas, Hydra is countering their claims by presenting old maps, some dating back several years, as evidence.

Reports suggest that Hydra is consulting with Baahubali Cranes operators on how to safely demolish these massive buildings, should it be deemed necessary.

As a result of these developments, demand for Lake View Apartments has significantly dro pped. Potential buyers are now hesitant, fearing potential demolition or legal issues, and are avoiding purchasing apartments in these areas.

Among the proposals, the discoms have requested permission to increase the fixed charge per kilowatt from Rs. 10 to Rs. 50 for households consuming more than 300 units per month. Additionally, they seek to charge Rs. 7.65 per unit for all industrial categories. The fixed charge for industries is also proposed to rise

The government currently provides free electricity to households consuming less than 200 units per month under the *Griha Jyoti* scheme. There will be no increase in fixed charges for households consuming up to 299 units. More than 30 lakh households in the state have electricity connections, with over 80% using less than 300 units per month.

The report from the discoms was originally due to the council by November 30, 2023, but was delayed due to the assembly elections. Although the ERC ordered the report to be submitted by January 2024, the Lok Sabha elections further postponed it. As a result, the ERC has imposed a fine of Rs. 21 lakh on the discoms for delays since February.

Telangana Government **Announces Dussehra Holidays**

TPN, Telangana: The Telangana government has announced Dussehra holidays for schools, from October 2nd to 14th. The Telangana School Education Department has issued orders to this effect. The festival of Dussehra will be celebrated on October 12. According to the order, schools will reopen on the 15th of October.

Before Dussehra, the Bathukamma festival, which lasts for nine days, will be celebrated across Telangana. The festivities will begin with the Engilipula Bathukamma on October 2 and conclude with Saddula Bathukamma on Durgashtami, two days before Dussehra.



Good News for Orugallu Residents... Warangal to Become a Health Hub!

TPN, Warangal: The Minister of Medical and Health, Damodara announced Rajanarsimha, that Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy is credited with establishing eight medical colleges in Telangana. He emphasized that Orugallu (Warangal), with its rich history, is being given significant focus in the fields of medicine and health. The goal is to develop Orugallu into a major health hub and a center for super-specialty treatments.

While inaugurating the Narsampet Medical College and Hospital today, along with Revenue and District In-charge Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy and Endowments Minister Konda Surekha, Minister Damodara Rajanarsimha highlighted the government's

Choreographer Johnny Master was arrested by the SWOT police in Goa and produced in court there. He is being transferred to Hyderabad on a PT warrant and is expected to be presented before the Upparapally court tomorrow.

High Court Issues Notice to Govt on Legality of 'Mission Chabutra' and 'Operation Romeo'



TPN, Hyderabad: The Telangana High Court has issued notices to the state government, including the Principal Secretary (Home), the Director General of Police (DGP), and the Hyderabad Police Commissioner, in response to a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) challenging the legality of the police operations "Mission Chabutra" and "Operation Romeo." The petition was filed by social activist SQ Masood, who claims these operations are arbitrary, illegal, and discriminatory.

Masood argued that the operations, which involve late-night counselling, random searches, and alleged public harassment, violate constitutional rights guaranteed under Articles 14 (right to equality) and 21 (right to life and personal liberty). The petitioner urged the court to declare these actions illegal, asserting that they are carried out without legal authority and infringe upon the personal liberties of citizens.

The petition also highlighted that police were imposing restrictions on businesses by forcing shops, hotels, and street vendors to close between 10:30 p.m. and 11:00 p.m., which Masood claimed violates Government Order 15 issued by the Labour Department in May 2015. Additionally, he raised concerns about the police conducting unwarranted frisking of commuters, further violating their constitutional rights under Articles 14, 19 (right to freedom), and 21.

The court has sought a response from the government on the legality and constitutionality of these operations. Further hearings on the matter are expected in the coming days.

Relatives of Student Attack Hostel Warden in Mahabubabad

TPN, Mahabubabad: A hostel warden, whose role is to ensure the safety and well-being of students, has caused an uproar in Mahabubabad. The warden's inappropriate behavior led to a violent confrontation with the student's relatives, resulting in a commotion in the area.

In Mahabubabad district, Gade Rukma Reddy, a warden at a private school, allegedly misbehaved with a student. Upon learning about the incident, the student's relatives attacked Rukma Reddy, subjecting him to a physical assault.

The attack occurred on school premises, causing panic among the children. The student's relatives are



demanding immediate action against the warden and his removal from the position. When the assault happened, the warden was reportedly locked in the principal's office. The school management is facing criticism for their handling of the situation, with the student's parents expressing frustration over the perceived protection of the errant warden.

Telangana: 3 Missing **TMREIS Students Traced**



TPN, Hyderabad: Three Class 10 students from the Telangana Minorities Residential Educational Institutions Society (TMREIS) in Nalgonda district, who had been missing since September 17, have been traced.

According to the police, the students were found returning to Hyderabad after visiting a mall around midnight on Tuesday, September 17. The boys -Abdul Rehman, Taufeeq, and Mujeeb – were brought to Devarkanda police station.

The students had gone missing earlier that day after being reprimanded for bringing alcohol onto the school campus. Despite the school's efforts to locate them, they did not return that night, prompting a search by local authorities and raising concerns among parents and school officials.



Take Action Against Revanth Reddy: Harish Rao's Letter to Mallikarjuna Kharge

- Harish Rao stated that the language used by Revanth Reddy towards KCR is inappropriate.

TPN, Telangana: Former Telangana minister and BRS MLA Harish Rao has written an open letter to AICC president Mallikarjuna Kharge, stating that the language used by Revanth Reddy against KCR and the BRS was inappropriate. He urged Kharge to take disciplinary action against Revanth Reddy. Harish Rao also accused the Congress of adopting a double standard in addressing the inappropriate and offensive comments made by Revanth Reddy.

He recalled that the Congress Party had organized nationwide protests in re-



sponse to comments made by a BJP MLA against Rahul Gandhi, yet no action has been taken against Revanth Reddy's remarks. Harish Rao criticized the Congress, saying, "The Congress party has one rule in Delhi and another rule in the streets."

Harish Rao also argued that Revanth

Reddy's comments were against the spirit of the Constitution and demanded strict action against him within the party. He further alleged that false cases were being filed against BRS leaders and activists with the involvement of the police, and he criticized Telangana's leadership under Revanth Reddy as dictatorial.

Union Minister Bandi Sanjay Accuses Madrasas of Fostering Terrorism

TPN, Telangana: Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Bandi Sanjay Kumar, stirred controversy with his remarks accusing certain madrasas of being "breeding grounds for terrorism" and a threat to national security. Speaking at the inauguration of a girls' hostel block at



Sri Vidyaranya Avasa Vidyalayam in Jammikunta, Karimnagar district, on Wednesday, September 19, Sanjay alleged that some madrasas are involved in teaching extremist activities, though he did not provide specific evidence to back his claims.

Sanjay's statement included accusations that certain madrasas are training students to use AK-47 rifles, even employing broomsticks for demonstrations. "Madrasas that provide training in making AK-47 rifles even with the help of broomsticks are breeding grounds for terrorism and pose a danger to the country's security," he claimed, raising questions about the government's decision to fund such institutions, which he alleged are promoting extremism.

In addition to his comments on madrasas, Sanjay Kumar criticized the Telangana government for not providing sufficient support to schools that promote "Indian Sanatana culture and traditions," such as Shishumandir schools. He expressed disappointment over the lack of government funding for these institutions.

Targeting the state government's approach to education, Sanjay also highlighted the ongoing teacher and sanitation worker vacancies in Telangana's schools, accusing the administration of neglect. "Despite thousands of teacher positions and over 20,000 sanitation worker posts remaining vacant, the state has failed to fill these roles," he noted, expressing frustration over the absence of a dedicated education minister in the state cabinet.

BRS Leaders Accuse Police of Colluding with Congress in Attacks



TPN, Telangana: Former Ministers Vemula Prashanth Reddy and Jagadish Reddy, along with MLAs Kaushik Reddy, Vivekananda Goud, Sanjay Kumar, RS Praveen Kumar, and other BRS leaders, have lodged a complaint with the state DGP in Hyderabad, alleging that BRS leaders and activists are being targeted across the state. They claim that lower-level police officers are involved in these attacks, often in collaboration with Congress supporters.

Jagadish Reddy stated that BRS leaders have been attacked in various locations, including Suryapet Tirumalagiri and during a visit to flood-affected areas in Khammam district. He mentioned that Siddipet Harish Rao's camp office was also attacked and accused the ACP and CI of being complicit in the assault on Kaushik Reddy's house. The leaders expressed concern that public trust in the police is diminishing, particularly when Congress leaders' birthday celebrations are reportedly being held at police stations.

The complaint submitted to the DGP seeks to safeguard the integrity of the police force. The BRS leaders criticized the Chief Minister's conduct, suggesting it has led to widespread unrest and undermined confidence in the government. They emphasized that the party remains resolute despite these challenges and rejected attempts to diminish their efforts.

Minister Ponguleti Criticizes Opposition Amid Accusations

TPN, Telangana: Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy sharply criticized opposition parties for their negative remarks about his government. Speaking to the media on September 18, he expressed frustration that the opposition's criticism stems from their inability to accept the progress made by his administration. Reddy accused the opposition of attempting to deflect attention from corruption committed by previous governments.

He highlighted that Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's administration is committed to fulfilling not only the promises made but also those not previously promised. Reddy emphasized the gov-

ernment's dedication to improving education and healthcare. He noted that a survey of Mission Bhagiratha revealed that 53 percent of households are not receiving adequate water supply. Additionally, he pointed out that Rs. 73,000 crores have been allocated to the agri-



culture sector, and Rs. 18,000 crores in farmers' loans have been waived. He assured that all eligible farmers will receive loan waivers.

Reddy also criticized the previous BRS government for failing to take signif-

icant actions during their decade-long rule. He accused them of hindering the Congress's efforts and neglecting the development of Orugallu. Reddy announced that ration cards will be issued to eligible individuals either by the end of this month or in the first week of next month. He stressed the importance of having a vision for development rather than engaging in opportunism.

Regarding education, Reddy highlighted that his government has invested Rs. 650 crores, with plans to build integrated schools in 119 constituencies. Each school, covering 25 acres, will be constructed with a budget of Rs. 110

crores and will include comprehensive facilities. He criticized the opposition for being unable to accept the progress achieved by the government and accused them of living under the illusion that their past mistakes continue to affect current governance.

Chamala Kiran Kumar Reddy Criticizes NDA Government's Push for Simultaneous Elections



TPN, Hyderabad: MP Chamala Kiran Kumar Reddy, in a speech at Gandhi Bhavan, voiced his criticism of the NDA government's push for simultaneous elections. He pointed out the lack of clarity in the report prepared by former President Ram Nath Kovind's committee regarding consultations and meeting details about the proposal.

Reddy emphasized that implementing simultaneous elections would require at least 18 constitutional amendments and questioned the feasibility of conducting elections simultaneously in four states. He accused BJP leaders of misleading the public and diverting attention from more pressing issues facing the nation.

Highlighting the complexity of the proposal, Reddy noted that for simultaneous elections to be enacted, 2/3 approval is required from both the Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha, as well as support from at least 14 state legislatures. While he acknowledged the potential benefits of simultaneous elections, he stressed the importance of practical considerations, including state approvals and logistical challenges.

Reddy also questioned why the central government did not implement simultaneous elections during recent parliamentary elections, citing that only 10 out of 194 countries worldwide currently practice this system. His remarks call for more thoughtful deliberation before moving forward with such a significant change.

MP Etela Rajender Criticizes HYDRA's Legality and Motives



TPN, Telangana: Malkajgiri MP Etela Rajender has made controversial statements regarding the Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring Protection (HYDRA), established by Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's government. During a recent BJP membership registration event in Janagama district and a blood donation camp organized in conjunction with Prime Minister Modi's birthday, Rajender addressed the media, raising concerns about HYDRA's legal foundation.

Rajender claimed that the establishment of HYDRA lacks legal backing and was not discussed with any cabinet minister, suggesting that if HYDRA were to carry significant responsibilities, it should have been debated in the legislature and formalized through legal channels. He implied that Revanth Reddy introduced HYDRA to advance his personal agenda.

Rajender also criticized Reddy's approach to addressing illegal constructions. He accused Reddy of using HYDRA to portray past governments and chief ministers negatively while failing to address the mistakes of officials who issued permits for these constructions. Rajender argued that it is unconstitutional for a Chief Minister to demolish legally permitted constructions after collecting taxes on them for 30 years. He expressed frustration, asserting that Revanth Reddy is acting as if it is his personal domain, rather than acknowledging that previous governments had made efforts to aid the poor and that the buildings in question were constructed with government authorization.

The arrested students—Charan Tej, who studies engineering in Chennai, Kaushik Tu Boti, and Syed Sarfaraz—were taken into custody after their risky decision to sell drugs for easy money jeopardized their futures. The value of the seized drugs is estimated at Rs. 70,000.

A case has been registered against a Chennai-based supplier who provided the drugs to the students. The supplier is currently absconding. Excise Enforcement Director VV Kamalasan Reddy and Assistant Commissioner Anil Kumar Reddy praised the Shirisha team for their successful operation.

Tension Eases in Telangana's Narayanpet Ahead of Milad un Nabi Celebrations

TPN, Narayanpet: Mild communal tensions briefly surfaced in Narayanpet District, Telangana, during preparations for the upcoming Milad un Nabi celebrations. The situation escalated on Thursday when individuals reportedly removed green flags that had been placed for the festivities.

In response to the incident, local authorities swiftly intervened to disperse the gathering and restore order. Police forces acted quickly to bring the situation under control, ensuring calm in the area.

The incident drew attention online, with MBT spokesperson Amjed Ullah Khan sharing videos and commenting on the situation. He noted that the Muslim community had rescheduled their Milad un Nabi celebration to avoid any potential conflict, especially considering the recent 10-day Ganesh festival, which concluded with the Ganesh Visarjan on Wednesday.

Rescheduled Milad un Nabi Celebrations

Originally set for September 16 this year, the Milad un Nabi celebrations in Telangana were postponed to Thursday, allowing the Ganesh festival to conclude peacefully. This is not the first time such a rescheduling has occurred, as last year's Milad un Nabi procession in Hyderabad was also postponed due to overlap with the Ganesh immersion festivities.

Today, in Hyderabad, a Milad un Nabi procession is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. As part of a broader initiative, the city will also host year-long events to mark the 1500th anniversary of the Prophet Muhammad's birth. The celebrations will feature seminars, natiya mehfils, and literary competitions, adding a cultural dimension to the religious occasion. The authorities continue to monitor the situation closely, ensuring the celebrations proceed smoothly across the region.

L&T Hyderabad Metro Rail's X Account Hacked

TPN, Hyderabad: In an alarming inci dent, the official X account (previously known as Twitter) of L&T Hyderabad Metro Rail (@ltmhyd) was hacked in the early hours of Thursday. The hackers posted a message declaring "THIS IS HACKED ACCOUNT!!!!" and made attempts to involve users in a cryptocurrency scam.

The unauthorized tweet contained a token address and encouraged followers to "BUY NOW!" in an effort to artificially inflate its value for financial gain. Additionally, the hackers shared a cryptocurrency wallet address, targeting unsuspecting users with fraudulent schemes.



The post read: "THIS IS HACKED ACCOUNT!!!! INTRODUCING \$HACKED ON SOLANA. For each account we hack, we publish the token address so we can pump it and make profits together.

ugNjBufjn1jeU9U1pPNiUMRbwFTj7UzgTi. BUY NOW!"

In response to the breach, L&T Hyderabad Metro Rail promptly released an official statement, urging users to refrain from clicking on any links or engaging with posts from the compromised account. "Please avoid interacting with any content until further notice. We are addressing the issue and will provide updates soon. Stay safe!" the statement advised.

The incident has raised concerns among followers, and efforts are currently underway to restore the account's security.

Telangana Set to Ban Overage Vehicles in Hyderabad and Other Districts by 2025

TPN, Telangana: The Telangana govern ment is preparing to ban overage vehicles from operating on the roads of Hyderabad and other districts across the state, with the new regulations expected to take effect from January 1, 2025. A vehicle is classified as "overage" if it has been in use for 15 years or more. Such vehicles will be required to be scrapped, and owners may face penalties if they continue to operate these vehicles beyond the designated period.

However, there is an exception for overage vehicles that pass a mandatory fitness test. These vehicles will be granted an extension, allowing them to remain on the road for an additional



3–5 years, provided the owner pays a green tax. This exception, however, does not extend to approximately 10,000 government vehicles.

Large Number of Overage Vehicles in Hyderabad

The report highlights that Hyderabad

alone has a significant number of overage vehicles, including 17 lakh motorcycles, 3.5 lakh cars, 1 lakh goods vehicles, and 20,000 auto-rickshaws. These vehicles may soon face mandatory scrappage if the proposed vehicle scrappage policy, drafted by the Regional Transport Authority, is approved by the government.

Thispolicyisbeingintroducedtopromote cleaner air and reduce pollution in the state, and it marks a significant shift in Telangana's approach to environmental sustainability and road safety. The government is expected to release further details on implementation as the policy's approval process advances.

Food Safety Department Raids Supermarket and Sweet Shop in Hyderabad

Food Safety Department conducted surprise raids on a supermarket and a sweet shop in West Maredpally, Hyderabad, uncovering several violations related to food safety and labeling regulations.

The raids targeted Ratnadeep Retail Private Limited and Olive Mithai Shop. At Ratnadeep, officials discovered that frozen packed food items, including McCain Potato Bites and Heritage Mozzarella Cheese, were not being stored according to the FIFO (First In, First Out) method, a crucial practice to ensure freshness. Additionally, packets of blueberries were missing important labeling details such as the FSSAI license number, logo, importer address, packaging, and use-by dates, all of which are mandatory under food safety laws.

Similarly, at Olive Mithai Shop,

TPN, Hyderabad: The Telangana officials found that packed food items, including Namkeen, Mixture, and Chakodi, lacked proper labels. Key details such as the FSSAI license number, logo, and manufacturer information were missing. Sweets packed and sold on-site were also found to be in violation of labeling regulations.

> The Food Safety Department is expected to take strict action against both establishments for these lapses, with penalties likely to be imposed to ensure compliance with food safety standards.




TGRTC Buses to Ply to and from UPSC Exam **Centers Between** September 22-29

Stock Markets Rally in First 100 Days of Modi 3.0, **Defying Initial Concerns**

strong momentum during the first Modi's third term, defying early concerns over a possible hike in capital gains tax and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) not winning the 2024 Lok Sabha elections with the overwhelming majority some had predicted. Despite these uncertainties, India's benchmark indices, Nifty and Sensex, have surged to record highs, delivering impressive gains for investors.

The Narendra Modi-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) government completed 100 days of its third consecutive term on September 17, 2024. Within this short span, the stock market exhibited an impressive performance, with broad-based optimism buoying investor senti-

Sensex and Nifty Hit Record Small-cap and mid-cap stocks also

During the first 100 days of Modi 3.0, the 30-share BSE Sensex surged by nearly 6,500 points, representing a gain of over 8.4%. On September 18, 2024, the Sensex closed at 82,948.23, a significant increase from 76,448.23 on June 9, 2024, the day Narendra Modi was sworn in as Prime Minister for the third time. Meanwhile, the broader Nifty50 index also saw a notable rise, jumping by nearly 2,087 points or 9%, to close at 25,377.55 points on September 18.

This rally has been marked by optimism in the broader market, with sectors across the board performing well. Both Sensex and Nifty reached record highs on September 17, just as the government celebrated 100 days of Modi 3.0. However, the indices ended marginally lower on September 18, likely reflecting profit booking from investors following the substantial gains.

Sectoral Outperformance

Several sectors have stood out during this period. The Nifty IT Index, a key

The stock markets have witnessed performer in India's stock market, gained more than 8% between June 100 days of Prime Minister Narendra 10 and September 18, buoyed by optimism around India's thriving tech industry. Another standout performer was the Nifty Healthcare Index, Modi 1.0's Stock Market Sucwhich rose by nearly 17%, driven by strong demand in pharmaceuticals and healthcare services.

> Beyond the traditional sectors, defence, electric vehicles (EVs), real estate, and infrastructure stocks saw substantial upticks. These sectors gained momentum following government policy announcements, particularly in defence procurement and electric mobility, which attracted investor interest. The government's updated electric mobility policy, which outlines a roadmap for increasing the adoption of EVs in India, provided a particular boost to EV-related stocks.

performed exceptionally well. The BSE Smallcap Index soared over 15% during the first 100 days of Modi 3.0, while the BSE Midcap Index jumped 10%. This broad-based market rally reflects not only large-cap companies' gains but also the rising confidence in smaller firms and emerging sectors.

Contrast with Modi 2.0

The strong performance of the stock market in Modi 3.0 contrasts sharply with the market's reaction to the early days of Modi 2.0. When Modi returned to power for his second term in 2019, the markets faced significant headwinds, resulting in the Sensex declining by over 2,800 points and the Nifty falling by 1,000 points within the first 100 days.

Several factors contributed to the negative sentiment during Modi 2.0, including concerns about the global economic slowdown, uncertainty in the banking sector, and fears of escalating trade tensions. This cautious sentiment weighed on the Indian stock markets during that period. However, it's important to note

that despite the weak start in Modi's second term, the markets eventually recovered as economic reforms and policies began to bear fruit.

In contrast to Modi 2.0, Modi's first tenure in 2014 triggered a sharp rally in the stock market, similar to the current trend. Between May 26 and September 3, 2014, both Nifty and Sensex posted nearly 11% gains. This surge reflected investor optimism around Modi's promises of economic reforms, infrastructure development, and policies aimed at boosting growth and investment.

The market rally in Modi 1.0 was driven by hopes that his pro-business stance and reformist agenda would stimulate India's economic growth. As a result, investors piled into Indian stocks, pushing the market to new highs.

Outlook for Modi 3.0

The impressive performance of the stock market in the first 100 days of Modi 3.0 suggests that investors are confident in the government's ability to drive economic growth and implement key reforms. Despite concerns over global economic challenges, India's stock markets have shown resilience, benefiting from robust domestic demand and strong government initiatives in sectors such as infrastructure, defence, and electric mobility.

As the government continues to roll out policies and reforms, particularly in areas such as taxation, infrastructure, and energy, investors will be closely watching how these developments impact the broader economy and market performance. While it remains to be seen how the stock markets will perform over the longer term, the initial signs of Modi 3.0 point to continued optimism and confidence in India's economic future.



ZIMPOIDWE TO CUITZUO ETEPHONES TO **Feed Its Citizens Amid Drought**

decision to cull 200 elephants to feed its citizens, as the country grapples with a severe drought that has left nearly half of its population at risk of acute hunger. Tinashe Farawo, spokesperson for the Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Authority, announced the move, stating that the elephant population in Zimbabwe has grown beyond the land's capacity, and the culling is part of an effort to provide food to those in need.

The drought in Zimbabwe, one of the worst in decades, has significantly worsened food insecurity across the country. This decision to cull elephants follows a similar move in neighboring Namibia, where the government authorized the culling of 700 wild animals, including elephants, to provide food for citizens facing hunger. Namibia has already distributed over 125,000 pounds of meat from 150 culled animals, according to its Ministry of Environment, Forestry, and Tourism.

Zimbabwe's elephant population is the second-largest in the world, behind Botswana, with more than 84,000 elephants, nearly double the country's estimated capacity of 45,000. The growing number of elephants has created significant pressure on the environment, particularly in light of the ongoing drought. Environment Minister Sithembiso Nyoni recently told parliament that the country's forests and resources cannot sustain the current elephant population, and the resulting resource shortages have intensified human-wildlife conflicts. Elephants, in search of food and water, are increasingly venturing beyond protected parks, bringing them into contact with humans and leading to dangerous confrontations.

In response to this crisis, the government plans to use the elephant meat to alleviate protein deficiencies in some of the most affected regions. Nyoni noted that communities, particularly women, would be organized to help preserve and distribute the meat. Zimbabwe's drought, exacerbated by climate change and El Niño, has devastated crops and livelihoods, pushing the country into further food insecurity.

While the government sees the cull as a necessary step to manage elephant overpopulation and provide muchneeded food, the decision has drawn sharp criticism from animal rights advocates and conservationists. Farai Maguwu, head of the Zimbabwebased Center for Natural Resource Governance, strongly condemned the cull on social media, arguing that elephants have a right to exist and

Zimbabwe has made the controversial that future generations should be able to see them in their natural habitats. He called for the culling to be halted, reflecting the broader concern among conservationists that such actions could lead to unsustainable demand for bushmeat.

> Keith Lindsay, a conservation biologist and natural resources consultant, echoed these concerns, warning that relying on wildlife to address food insecurity could have long-term consequences for elephant populations and the ecosystems they inhabit. The growing demand for bushmeat could threaten the stability of elephant populations and other wildlife, especially in regions already strained by environmental pressures.

> Despite the opposition, Farawo defended the cull as necessary for both human survival and wildlife management. He pointed out that Zimbabwe has not conducted an elephant cull since 1988, and the current situation requires urgent action. The country has been dealing with increasing human-elephant conflicts, with elephants causing significant harm to communities. In recent weeks, several fatal elephant attacks have been reported. Farawo noted that just last week, a woman was killed by an elephant in the northern part of the country, and a similar incident occurred the week before. These tragedies highlight the growing danger posed by elephants encroaching on human settlements.

> The decision to cull elephants is part of Zimbabwe's broader strategy to reduce these conflicts while addressing the immediate food needs of its population. According to Farawo, the culling will begin once the necessary paperwork is completed, and it will primarily target regions with dense elephant populations. While the government remains firm in its stance, it acknowledges that the practice is a difficult but necessary measure in the face of mounting challenges.

The culling of elephants has sparked an international debate about the balance between wildlife conservation and human survival. As Zimbabwe moves forward with its plans, the country faces increasing pressure from conservationists and animal rights groups to find alternative solutions to its food security crisis without endangering its wildlife. However, for many in Zimbabwe, the immediate concern is survival, and the government's controversial decision may provide a temporary relief to the pressing issue of hunger in the country.

EY India Responds to Allegations of Employee's Death Due to Overwork

firms, has responded to criticism following a viral letter from a woman who claimed her 26-year-old daughter, Anna Sebastian, died of "overwork" just four months after joining the company. The firm expressed deep sadness over Anna's death in July 2024 and conveyed its condolences to the family.

"We are deeply saddened by Anna Sebastian's tragic and untimely passing, and our deepest condolences go to the bereaved family," EY

Ernst & Young (EY), one of the Big 4 consulting said in a statement on Wednesday. The company emphasized that it is providing all possible assistance to Anna's family during this difficult time.

> The controversy arose after Anna's mother wrote a letter to EY India Chairman Rajiv Memani, which went viral on social media. In the letter, she accused the company of overworking her daughter, leading to her death. She also mentioned that no one from the organization attended Anna's funeral.

According to the letter, Anna was enthusiastic about joining EY, as it was her first job after clearing her Chartered Accountancy exams in November 2023. She joined EY's Pune office in March 2024. "She was full of life, dreams, and excitement for the future. But four months later, on July 20th, 2024, my world collapsed when I received the devastating news that Anna had passed away," her mother wrote.

In its statement, EY emphasized that employ-

ee well-being is of the highest priority for the firm. "We are taking the family's concerns with the utmost seriousness and humility. While no measure can compensate for the loss experienced by the family, we are committed to continuing to support them and will work towards improving our workplace for all employees."

The company reiterated its commitment to providing a healthier work environment for its 100,000 employees across India.







Chandrababu Naidu **Claims Animal Fat** in Tirupati Laddoos; **YSR Congress Denies** Accusation

In a heated exchange, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has made shocking allegations that animal fat was used in the preparation of Tirupati laddoos during the tenure of the YSR Congress party, which is led by YS Jagan Mohan Reddy. Naidu's comments were made at a National Democratic Alliance (NDA) legislative party meeting, where he criticized the previous government for compromising the quality of prasad at the Sri Venkateswara Temple in Tirupati.

According to Naidu, the YSR Congress party's leadership tarnished the sanctity of the revered Tirumala shrine by allegedly using animal fat instead of ghee in the preparation of the iconic laddoos, which are traditionally given as prasad to devotees. He stated, "In the past five years, they contaminated the sacred Tirumala laddu. This revelation has caused concern. However, we are now using pure ghee and striving to protect the sanctity of the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD)."

The YSR Congress has vehemently denied these allegations, calling them malicious and politically motivated. Senior YSR Congress leader and Rajya Sabha MP YV Subba Reddy responded by accusing Naidu of damaging the faith of millions of Hindus. Reddy described Naidu's comments as "extremely malicious," stating, "No person would speak such words or make such accusations."

In a bold challenge, Reddy offered to take an oath before the almighty regarding the purity of the Tirumala prasad and questioned whether Naidu would do the same with his family. He emphasized that Naidu's comments reflect a desperate attempt to gain political traction at the expense of religious sentiments.

PM Modi's US Visit: Quad Summit, UN Assembly, and Potential Meeting with Trump



Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to visit the United States from September 21 to 23, with a busy itinerary that includes participation in the Quad Summit, attending the UN General Assembly session, and engaging in multiple bilateral meetings. He is also scheduled to meet with top CEOs and business leaders, and will address the Indian community at a diaspora event in New York.

Ahead of this visit, former US President Donald Trump, who is currently campaigning for the Republican presidential nomination, announced that he plans to meet PM Modi during the trip. Despite Trump's claims, the Ministry of External Affairs has not confirmed this meeting as part of the Prime Minister's official schedule. A foreign ministry spokesperson stated, "Many meetings are being fixed and the process is ongoing. At this moment, we can't confirm any specific meet."

During a campaign event in Michigan, Trump praised Modi as "a fantastic man" and expressed enthusiasm about their potential meeting. He also commented on India's economic practices, noting that while Indians are "the sharpest people," the country imposes heavy tariffs on im-

ports, which he described as being "very tough."

As the US approaches the elections on November 5, with postal voting already underway, Trump is running against Democrat candidate Kamala Harris, who is seeking her first term as President. As the Prime Minister engages with global leaders and the Indian diaspora, the potential meeting with Trump could add another layer to the already complex relationship between the two nations.

The outcomes of this visit, particularly discussions around trade and tariffs, could be pivotal as both countries navigate their roles on the world stage, especially in the context of growing global challenges.

Quad More Strategically Aligned, Relevant Than Ever: White House



The upcoming Quad Summit in Wilmington, Delaware, is set to showcase the strengthened strategic alignment and relevance of the Quad coalition, comprising the United States, India, Japan, and Australia. John Kirby, the National Security Council Strategic Communications Director, emphasized the significance of this summit in a recent press briefing, stating, "We believe you'll see... that the Quad is more strategically aligned and more relevant than ever before."

Originally, it was India's turn to host the summit, but at Washington's request, the meeting will take place in the U.S. President Joe Biden will host the leaders of the other three nations—Prime Minister Narendra Modi of India, Prime Minister Fumio Kishida of Japan, and Prime Minister Anthony Albanese of Australia—on September 21.

This summit is particularly noteworthy as it marks the first occasion that Biden will host foreign leaders in his hometown of Wilmington. Kirby highlighted Biden's eagerness to share his community with the leaders, underscoring the personal connections that shape both politics and foreign policy.

During the summit, Biden plans to engage in individual meetings with each of the leaders before transitioning to a plenary session. This gathering will also serve as a platform to discuss pressing issues, including China, which Kirby noted would be "high on the agenda."

Over the past three years, Biden has prioritized rebuilding America's alliances and partnerships across the Indo-Pacific region, as seen through initiatives like AUKUS and the trilateral Camp David summit with Japan and South Korea. He also recently held the first-ever US-Japan-Philippines Leaders' Summit, further underscoring the importance of these alliances.

Prime Minister Modi will commence his three-day visit to the U.S. on September 21, attending not only the Quad Summit but also addressing the UN General Assembly's "Summit of the Future." During his visit, he is scheduled to engage with the Indian community in New York on September 22.

As the Quad nations prepare for this pivotal meeting, the focus will be on enhancing collaboration and addressing mutual challenges, solidifying their role as key players in the Indo-Pacific region. The summit aims to strengthen diplomatic ties and showcase the unity of these democratic nations in the face of evolving global dynamics.

Deadly Explosions in Lebanon Heighten Hezbollah-Israel Tensions

At least 32 people have died and over 3,250 others injured following a series of explosions involving walkie-talkies and pagers used by Hezbollah members in Lebanon. The blasts, which occurred over the last two days, have raised concerns of an escalating conflict with Israel.

On Wednesday, a significant explosion in Hezbollah's Beirut stronghold resulted in at least 20 fatalities and over 450 injuries, occurring near a Hezbollah-organized funeral for victims of an earlier blast. The day before, a separate series of explosions involving pagers led to the deaths of 12 people, including two children, and injured approximately 2,800.

Hezbollah has attributed responsibility for these incidents to Israel, declaring the country "fully responsible for this criminal aggression" and pledging revenge. Although Israel has not officially commented, sources allege that Israeli spies remotely detonated explosives in a batch of 5,000 pagers before they were smuggled into Lebanon.

In response to the escalating situation, Hezbollah has engaged Israeli artillery positions with rocket fire. However, the Israeli military has reported no damage or casualties from these exchanges.

The United States has urged all parties to refrain in Lebanon.



from escalating tensions in the region. National Security Council spokesperson John Kirby emphasized that military operations are not a viable solution to the ongoing crisis. UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres also expressed concerns, warning that the pager explosions indicate a "serious risk of a dramatic escalation" in Lebanon.

The UN Security Council is set to convene on Friday to address the recent blasts. The situation remains tense as Israel and Hezbollah continue their conflict along the Lebanese border, which has intensified since the war in Gaza began on October 7, 2023, following a Hamas attack on Israeli towns.



Canada Reduces International Study Permits, Impacting Indian Students

In a significant policy shift aimed at decreasing the number of temporary residents, Canada announced a reduction in international student permits and tightened foreign worker regulations. Prime Minister Justin Trudeau revealed that the country will issue 35% fewer study permits this year, with a further 10% reduction planned for next year.

Trudeau emphasized the need for stricter controls, stating, "Immigration is an advantage for our economy—but when bad actors abuse the system and take advantage of students, we crack down." In 2023, Canada approved 509,390 study permits, but this number is projected to fall to 437,000 by 2025. The new rules will also restrict work permit eligibility for some students' spouses and temporary foreign workers.

This decision comes as Trudeau's Liberal government faces challenges in public opinion ahead of upcoming federal elections. Recent statistics show that temporary residents, particularly students and workers, have doubled in Canada, rising from 1.4 million in 2022 to 2.8 million in 2024. The government aims to reduce this figure to 5% of the total population, down from 6.8% in April.

The impact on Indian students could be substantial, as Canada has been a favored destination for Indian nationals. Recent data indicates that approximately 427,000 Indian students are currently studying in Canada, representing a 260% increase from 2013 to 2022. Indian students constitute around 40% of all international students in Canada, and the new restrictions may push many to consider alternatives like the US, UK, or Australia for their studies. With growing concerns about the societal challenges attributed to immigration, including rising housing costs and living expenses, the Canadian government's measures reflect a more cautious approach to international student admissions and temporary worker programs.

India Gets US Court Summons In Alleged Plot To Murder Khalistani Terrorist

The US District Court for the Southern District of New York has summoned the Indian government in response to a civil lawsuit filed by Khalistani terrorist Gurpatwant Singh Pannun, who alleges a conspiracy to murder him. The summons names several high-profile individuals, including National Security Advisor Ajit Doval, former R&AW chief Samant Goel, R&AW agent Vikram Yadav, and Indian businessman Nikhil Gupta. The court has instructed the named parties to respond within 21 days.

Pannun, who leads the separatist group Sikhs for Justice and holds dual citizenship in the US and Canada, shared the summons on his social media account, which has since been withheld. This legal action follows reports from the Financial Times in November, indicating that US authorities had foiled an assassination plot against him, a claim later confirmed by the Biden administration.

In its initial response, the Indian External Affairs Ministry expressed concern over the lawsuit, stressing that it contradicts government policy. Former spokesperson Arindam Bagchi noted the situation warrants high-level scrutiny. Ex-



ternal Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar confirmed that India is investigating the matter but maintained that it would not disrupt the improving relations between India and the US.

Jaishankar emphasized that the US had shared critical information in good faith and that it had implications for India's own security landscape. US Ambassador to India Eric Garcetti also stated that this legal matter would not negatively impact bilateral ties.

Pannun is known for his incendiary rhetoric and threats against Indian officials and institutions, leading to his designation as a terrorist by New Delhi in 2020. The ongoing developments highlight tensions surrounding Khalistani separatism and its implications for international relations between India and the US.



¬ lobal benchmark Brent crude oil fell below \$70 per $oldsymbol{\mathsf{U}}$ barrel on September 10—the first time since December 2021—but has since risen to over \$74 per barrel in the past nine days. Despite this recent fluctuation, public sector oil marketing companies (OMCs) are not expected to immediately pass on these benefits to consumers or resume daily price revisions for petrol and diesel, according to a senior official from the petroleum ministry. The official noted that international crude prices remain highly volatile.

The recent decline in oil prices had sparked speculation that OMCs—Indian Oil Corporation (IOC), Bharat Petroleum Corporation (BPCL), and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation (HPCL)—might lower retail prices for fuels and revert to their previous practice of daily price updates. This practice was suspended over two years ago when oil prices soared to multi-year highs due to several factors, including the geopolitical instability following the Russia-Ukraine war.

Currently, OMCs are closely monitoring market conditions before making any pricing decisions. The petroleum ministry's official indicated that any changes would depend on sustained trends in international prices and overall market stability.

HEZBOLLAH PAGER ATTACKS ANEW TWISTIN THE GAZA CRISIS





In a covert operation that feels ripped from a spy thriller, a series of explosive "pager attacks" has added a new and dangerous dimension to the ongoing Gaza crisis. The sophisticated operation, allegedly carried out by Israeli agencies, targeted Hezbollah members, resulting in the deaths of nine individuals and injuries to over 2,700 civilians and fighters. Even Iran's ambassador to Lebanon, Mojtaba Amani, was injured in the explosions.

According to reports, Israeli intelligence intercepted Hezbollah's supply of pagers, a low-tech communication method the group still uses, and laced over 5,000 devices with explosives. The Taiwanese company, Gold Apollo, which allegedly provided the devices, has denied any involvement in the attack.

14 Dead, Over 300 Injured As Walkie-Talkies Explode In Hezbollah Units Across Lebanon, Israel's spy agency Mossad planted explosives inside pagers imported by Hezbollah months before Tuesday's detonations, Hezbollah has claimed.





The Strategic Blow

Though Israel has not officially claimed responsibility, the attack appears to be more than a tactical operation—it's a psychological strike. Israel and Hezbollah have engaged in a clandestine and complex conflict for years, carefully avoiding full-scale war. The pager attack represents another layer of this covert struggle, demonstrating Israel's ability to infiltrate Hezbollah's infrastructure.

Similar Israeli operations in the past, such as the 2021 assassination of Iranian scientist Mohsen Fakhrizadeh and the recent killing of Hamas leader Ismail Haniyeh in Tehran, underscore a broader pattern. These operations aim not just at physical targets but at displaying Israel's ability to strike anywhere, anytime, further destabilizing its opponents' morale and infrastructure.



Hezbollah's Dilemma

The attack comes at a time when Hezbollah faces difficult choices. Despite its strength and backing from Iran, the group has largely stayed out of the direct conflict with Israel following the October 2023 Hamas-led attack. This restraint likely stems from two strategic considerations.

First, engaging in a direct conflict in northern Israel would almost certainly trigger a massive Israeli and possibly U.S. military response, leading to heavy casualties and destruction in Lebanon. Hezbollah, as the dominant political and military force in Lebanon, would be held accountable for such losses.

Second, it is uncertain how far Iran, a crucial Hezbollah ally, would go to support the group in an open conflict. Tehran has yet to respond directly to recent Israeli operations, including the killing of senior Hamas leader Haniyeh. This raises questions about Iran's willingness to commit resources and military support to an all-out war, especially given its focus on maintaining regional stability and avoiding direct confrontation with the U.S.



..... A Delicate Balancing Act

Hezbollah's cautious approach seems aimed at prolonging the conflict in a way that keeps pressure on Israel without crossing the line into full-scale war. By focusing on small-scale operations and psychological warfare, Hezbollah can create disruptions in northern Israel without risking a catastrophic response.

Yet, even these tactical exchanges carry risks. The rising tensions between Hezbollah and Israel threaten ongoing diplomatic efforts to broker a ceasefire in Gaza, largely led by the U.S. Israeli hostages remain in Hamas custody, and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has made it clear that military operations will continue until Hamas is destroyed. In this volatile environment, any miscalculation could easily escalate into a broader regional conflict.

A Psychological Victory for Israel?

The pager attack represents more than just a hit on Hezbollah's physical resources—it's a symbolic victory. By targeting a "lowtech" communication system, Israel has disrupted Hezbollah's ability to coordinate forces and has sown doubt within its ranks about the security of its communications. In the short term, this serves as a significant psychological blow.

For Israel, securing psychological victories against its adversaries can be as important as tactical gains. The ability to penetrate Hezbollah's communications and infrastructure reinforces the notion that Israel remains a step ahead, capable of striking whenever it chooses.

The broader implications of the pager attack remain uncertain. While Hezbollah's communication network has been compromised, the long-term impact on the group's operational capabil-

> ity is yet to be seen. The ongoing tensions between Israel and Hezbollah, combined with the unresolved Gaza crisis, suggest that the conflict could spill over into 2025 and beyond.



For now, both sides continue their strategic dance—avoiding full-scale war but engaging in increasingly sophisticated and symbolic skirmishes. Whether this delicate balance can be maintained or whether another operation will spark a broader conflict remains to be seen. In the meantime, the region braces for what could come



Viewers can hype a video up to three times a week within seven days of its publication, providing a significant boost to visibility for smaller channels.

> YouTube's goal with these new features is to keep users engaged on its platform while facilitating better interactions between creators and their audiences. The Hype button also aims to provide a monetization avenue for creators by potentially allowing viewers to purchase additional hypes in the future.

Apple Sees Surge in Pre-Orders for iPhone 16 in India Ahead of Launch

Apple is experiencing a significant increase in pre-orders for its 'Make in India' iPhone 16, set to launch on September 20. Analysts report strong demand, particularly for the iPhone 16 Pro models, attributed to their competitive pricing compared to the previous 15 series.

The new iPhones will be available at Apple retail locations and authorized sellers across India, including Apple BKC in Mumbai and Apple Saket in New Delhi. According to Tarun Pathak, Director at Counterpoint Research, the base iPhone 16 model is seeing robust pre-order demand, and with attractive financing options, the new series is poised to break previous sales records.

Industry experts highlight that the push for local manufacturing is benefiting Apple, as the iPhone 16

models are being assembled in India for simultaneous release alongside global markets. Prabhu Ram from CyberMedia Research notes that Apple's growth is fueled by the premiumization trend in the Indian smartphone market, with older models like the iPhone 14 and 13 also expected to see increased sales during the festive season.

Driven by the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme, Apple's iPhone exports from India reached approximately \$5 billion from April to August this fiscal year, marking a 50% increase compared to the same period last year. The iPhone 16 Pro's strategic pricing is anticipated to attract more consumers, enhancing upgrade rates in the market.

Apple Intelligence Will be Available in German, Italian and More Languages



Apple has announced the expansion of its Apple Intelligence suite, introducing new language support for iPhone and other devices. Set to roll out in 2025, the newly added languages include German, Italian, and regional versions of English (specifically for India and Singapore). This expansion follows the initial release of Apple Intelligence, which was available in US English with the iOS 18 developer beta.

The AI features will be included in the upcoming iOS 18.1 update, scheduled for next month. However, the AI suite is currently not accessible, and only a few features—like writing tools, the Clean Up tool, and web page summarization—will be available at launch. Other functionalities, including an AI-enhanced Siri and the Image Playground, are expected to debut later next year.

In addition to the newly announced languages, Apple Intelligence will eventually support Chinese, French, Japanese, and Spanish. However, users in China and the European Union will not have access to these AI features. The entire iPhone 16 series, as well as the iPhone 15 Pro and Pro Max, will be compatible with the Apple Intelligence suite.

WhatsApp **Introduces Custom Chat Themes in Beta Testing**







WhatsApp, the widely-used instant messaging platform with over a billion users in India, is currently testing a new feature that allows for custom chat themes. This functionality, spotted in the beta version of the app, aims to enhance user experience by enabling customization of chat windows.

Android Authority, which has successfully activated some of these themes, reports that there are several color presets available, although not all themes can be accessed at this time. On Day 1 of the first Test against Bangladesh, Ravichandran Ashwin (102*) and Ravindra Jadeja (86*) orchestrated a remarkable recovery for India, combining for an unbroken seventh-wicket partnership of 195 runs. Their efforts helped India reach 339 for six after a shaky start, largely thanks to young pacer Hasan Mahmud's impressive spell.

Dulip Samaraweera Banned from Cricket for 20

Dulip Samaraweera, the former Sri Lankan cricketer, has been banned from holding any position within Cricket Australia or any State or Territory Association, including any W/ BBL teams, for a period of 20 years. This decision comes after the Cricket Australia Conduct Commission found him guilty of a serious breach of the Code of Conduct.

The investigation revealed that Samaraweera engaged in inappropriate behavior that violated section 2.23 of Cricket Australia's Code of Conduct. The incidents in question occurred while he was employed as the head coach of Cricket Victoria (CV). Samaraweera resigned from this role in May, just two weeks after his appointment, citing internal policy issues that hindered his preferred coaching appointments.

Cricket Victoria CEO Nick Cummins commented on Samaraweera's resignation, explaining that his specific coaching requests could not be accommodated due to established internal policies. Following discussions, Samaraweera



chose to step down from the position rather than continue in a role that did not align with

his expectations.

In a statement released on Thursday, Cricket Australia emphasized its commitment to maintaining a safe environment for all players and employees. The CA Integrity Department is responsible for investigating complaints under its Integrity Codes and Policies, which apply to both Cricket Australia and State & Territory Associations. The Conduct Commission is tasked with addressing matters referred by the Integrity Department, highlighting the organization's dedication to player welfare and accountability.

During his brief international career from 1993 to 1995, Samaraweera played in seven Test matches and five T20 Internationals. However, his recent actions have overshadowed his past contributions to the sport. This long ban serves as a stern reminder of the importance of upholding professional standards within the cricket community and ensuring a respectful environment for all involved.


