# **HYDRA** Launches Demolition Drive in Kukatpally and Ameenpur





TPN, Hyderabad: The Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring Agency (HYDRA) resumed its demolition operations on Sunday, September 22, after a two-week break, focusing on illegal constructions in Kukatpally and surrounding areas. The demolitions primarily target encroachments within the Kukatpally Nallacheruvu and extend to Sangareddy district's Ameenpur and Krishnarreddipet.

The Nallacheruvu area, which spans 27 acres, has seen significant encroachment, with 7 acres occupied by unauthorized buildings. A total of 25 apartments and other structures have been built within the buffer zone. HYDRA officials have marked 16 structures for demolition, including both completed and under-construction buildings.

Demolition activities began early in

HYDRA issued prior notices to the encroachers before beginning the demolition, emphasizing that the illegal constructions violated regulations, especially in sensitive buffer zones like Nallacheruvu.

The operation represents a significant effort by the agency to address encroachments and protect public spaces from unauthorized developments in Hyderabad.

**Govt Awaits Interpol's Red Corner Notice** for Ex-SIB Chief in **Phone Tapping Case** 

TPN, Hyderabad: The Telangana government has informed the state High Court that it expects Interpol to issue a red corner notice soon for T. Prabhakar Rao, former chief of the Special Intelligence Bureau (SIB), who is the prime suspect in a major phone tapping case. This development came to light during a court hearing coinciding with a bail plea filed

by Mekala Thirupathanna, a former additional superintendent of police, who is the fourth accused in the case and is currently in judicial custody.

Public prosecutor Palle Nageswara Rao, representing the state, informed the High Court that the government had sought the assistance of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), which acts as the nodal agency for Interpol in India. He stated that the CBI had completed its investigation, and the government now anticipates that Interpol will issue the red corner notice to apprehend Prabhakar Rao, who remains at large and is believed to have fled the 2nd page



## Congress CLP Meeting at Trident Hotel

Strategies for Strengthening Party and Governance in Telangana

## "Who Is Responsible for Our Loss?" -**Crying Victims of Hydra Demolitions**



**TPN, Hyderabad:** Hydra, which had paused demolitions in Hyderabad until recently, has resumed its operations. A crackdown on pond encroachments in Hyderabad has led to the demolition of 16 commercial sheds and the reclaiming of four acres of Kookatpalli Nalla Cheruvu today. Additionally, in Aminpur, three buildings were demolished, and one acre of land was acquired in Krishnareddypet.

Moreover, HYDRA officials demolished 25 villas in Patelguda, seizing three acres of land. In total, HYDRA officials reclaimed eight acres of government land across all three areas through demolitions today. The local business community was outraged by the actions of HYDRA, as police were heavily deployed to carry out the demolitions.

Locals were in tears as they watched their encroachments being demolished at Nalla Cheruvu in Kukatpalli. Many pleaded for at least two more months to vacate the premises, but HYDRA officials were unmoved. One victim, in particular, lamented, "My wife is pregnant, and they didn't even give me time to take our belongings.

" They expressed their anger, questioning who would be responsible for their losses. The victims accused the officials of carrying out demolitions without providing any prior notice, leaving them stranded and asking, "Is it right to throw us on the streets like this when we are making a living through small businesses?"

Business owners were heartbroken as they removed their belongings from the sheds while HYDRA officials carried out the demolitions. Many were devastated, describing the situation as deeply unfair. They

complained that had they been informed in advance, they would have vacated the premises and relocated their shops to other areas. Instead, the sudden demolition left them with no time to prepare.

The victims were emotional, crying out that the Revanth Reddy government had dragged them to a desperate situation. They demanded that the government take steps to ensure that middle-class citizens like them are not burdened by Hydra's demolition drives. Many busine ss owners claimed they were unaware that their shops were in the FTL (Full Tank Level) area or the buffer zone. Had they known, they said they would have relocated their businesses to a safer area. In tears, they asked the Revanth Reddy government, "How will we survive from tomorrow? Who will be held responsible for our loss?"

#### Mee Seva Down for 10 Days, Govt **Promises to Clear Backlogs**

TPN, Hyderabad: Telangana's online services platform, Mee Seva, has been experiencing a technical failure for the past 10 days, disrupting services across many parts of the state. Officials have identified the issue as a technical failure at the state's data centre, leaving citizens facing delays in various applications, particularly for jobs and higher education.

Mee Seva addressed the situation through its official social media account on X (formerly Twitter), assuring citizens that efforts are underway to restore the services and clear the backlog of applications as quickly as possible.

The service provider explained that the technical error has impacted access to documents uploaded for transactions made between July 10 and September 12, 2024. This has led to a large number of pending applications. To tackle the backlog, the Electronic Service Delivery (ESD) system will send the affected applications back to Mee Seva's Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs), who have been instructed to re-upload and resubmit the necessary documents.

Citizens whose applications are part of the backlog will receive updates about the status of their re-submissions via SMS. Mee Seva also confirmed that applications submitted after September 13, 2024, are being processed as usual.

Despite the service outage, the government has promised to resolve the technical issue and address the delayed applications at the earliest, assuring citizens that normalcy will soon return.

#### Govt Awaits Interpol's Red Corner Notice for Ex-SIB Chief in Phone Tapping Case

The phone tapping case, which rocked the political landscape of Telangana, involves the illegal interception of phone calls during the assembly elections in November 2023. According to the prosecutor, around 4,500 phone lines from non-Airtel subscribers were tapped between November 15 and 30, 2023. Shockingly, 80% of the phone data from Airtel subscribers could not be recovered as critical evidence, including hard drives, was destroyed by the accused.

The illegal surveillance primarily targeted opposition figures, including A. Revanth Reddy, who was Chief Minister. Reddy, along with his family and associates, was a key target of the operation. BJP

leader Eatala Rajender and his close associates were also victims of the phone tapping.

Opposing the bail plea of Thirupathanna, the public prosecutor argued that the former additional SP played a significant role in the conspiracy, acting on orders from higher-ups. The prosecutor further revealed that approximately 340 GB of data related to the illegal tapping was recovered from Thirupathanna's devices, and that the surveillance had deeply affected the lives of many individuals.

# KTR Vows to Fight For Damagundam Forest



**TPN, Telangana:** Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president KT Rama Rao (KTR) reaffirmed his party's commitment to opposing the destruction of the Damagundam forest in Vikarabad district. This comes amid protests by activists against the Telangana government's decision to hand over 2,900 acres of the forest land to the Indian Navy for setting up a radar station.

KTR took to social media platform X (formerly Twitter) on Sunday, September 22, to reiterate the party's stance, stating, "For 10 years, the KCR government refused to hand over nearly 3,000 acres of land to the Union Government to save the 12.5 lakh trees and the entire ecosystem." He criticized the current Congress-led state government for allegedly succumbing to pressure from the central government the forest's biodiversity and the larger ecosystem. and allowing the land transfer.

KTR emphasized that the BRS had taken a firm stand on this issue earlier this year in February and will continue to fight against the destruction of the forest, which he believes is vital for preserving the local environment and ecosystem. Meanwhile, a group of activists held a protest on Sunday at Dharna Chowk under the banner of "Save Damagundam JAC." The protest was sparked by concerns over the felling of trees and the long-term impact on the forest's delicate ecosystem. The Damagundam forest, located near Hyderabad, plays a crucial role in maintaining environmental balance in the region.

Protesters expressed their concerns about the environmental degradation that could follow the radar station's construction, stressing the need to protect

## **End of Wait**ing for Rythu **Bharosa:** Rs. 7,500 Deposited

TPN, Telangana: Farmers in Telangana can finally expect relief as the state government prepares to deposit Rs. 7,500 into their accounts as part of the Rythu Bharosa scheme. This initiative promises to provide agricultural investment assistance of Rs. 15,000 per acre annually for farmers with at least one acre of land, including tenant farmers.

State Agriculture Minister Thummala announced that the funds will be credited by the end of next month. The government has also recently formed a Cabinet Sub-Committee to develop new guidelines for the scheme, engaging with farmers, experts, and other stakeholders to ensure effective implementation.

The discussion surrounding the farmer loan waiver has been prominent, with the government having waived loans up to Rs. 2 lakh in three phases. However, many farmers with accounts containing incorrect details—such as mismatches with Aadhaar cards—have faced delays in receiving their funds. Those who borrowed beyond the Rs. 2 lakh limit have also been impacted, as the loan waiver funds were not deposited due to their failure to repay the extra amounts.

The upcoming Rythu Bharosa funds will mark a significant boost for farmers, who will see Rs. 7,500 deposited directly into their accounts. Additionally, farmers will receive Rs. 6,000 annually from the central government's PM Kisan scheme, with the 18th installment of Rs. 2,000 expected next month. This combined support amounts to a total of Rs. 9,500, significantly enhancing the financial assistance available to farmers during these challenging times.





## Complaint Filed Against Former AP CM Jagan Over Tirupati Laddu Controversy

TPN, Hyderabad: A complaint has been lodged against former Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy, along with Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) officials, over allegations of using low-quality ghee mixed with animal fat in the preparation of the sacred Tirupati Laddu prasadam. The complaint was filed by K Karuna Sagar, a city-based advocate, at the Saidabad police station.

In his complaint, Karuna Sagar, a practicing High Court lawyer, expressed deep concern, stating that the Tirupati laddu prasadam holds immense religious significance for Hindus and has been a symbol of divine blessings for over 300 years. The complaint stems from a lab test report from NDDB CALF Ltd, which allegedly confirmed the use of ghee mixed with animal fat in the laddu preparation.

This issue has sparked widespread concern among devotees, who have questioned the quality of ghee used in the revered offering. The TTD has since reassured the public that the sanctity of the prasadam has been restored, but the controversy continues to gain momentum.

The row escalated after Andhra Pradesh's former Chief Minister, N Chandrababu Naidu, accused the previous YSRCP government, led by Jagan Mohan Reddy, of allowing the use of animal fat in the preparation of the sacred laddus. In response,



the YSRCP dismissed these allegations as "diversion politics" and a "fabricated story."

The central government has requested a detailed report from the Andhra Pradesh government regarding the matter. Union Food Minister Pralhad Joshi has also called for a thorough investigation and assured appropriate action following the review of the findings.

Karuna Sagar, in his complaint, urged the police to investigate the matter and take legal action against Jagan Mohan Reddy and others allegedly involved, emphasizing that such actions deeply offend the religious sentiments of Hindus.

## Political Asceticism if No Mistakes Are Made: KTR's Challenge to Ponguleti

TPN, Telangana: BRS Working President KTR has challenged Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy to resign from politics if it is proven that no wrongdoing has occurred in the Amrit Scheme tenders. KTR demanded that an inquiry be conducted by a sitting judge immediately and called for Revanth Reddy to be prepared to step down from his post as Chief Minister if corruption is proven. KTR made these statements on Sun-

day while speaking to the media alongside party leaders at Telangana Bhavan in Hyderabad.

"Yesterday, a minister made a big claim that he would resign if it was proven that he had done something wrong. If he is truly sincere, let us both go to the Chief Justice of the High Court together and immediately request an inquiry by a sitting judge," KTR commented. "If the sitting judge confirms that no mistakes have been made, I will take up political asceticism," he added. KTR pointed out that the minister seems reluctant to approach the High Court CJ and instead suggested that they both approach the Central Vigilance Commissioner.

KTR also reiterated his demand that the Chief Minister and the minister cancel the tenders. He alleged that Revanth Reddy is facing accusations of illegally awarding tenders to his brother-in-law and questioned what the situation would be if his brother-in-law were not involved. "After running the government for ten years, they claim not to know where corruption is happening?" KTR asked,

The campaign, supported by BRS leaders, began

and cancel the tenders immediately.

KTR also criticized Chief Minister Revanth for neglecting the Singareni coal workers and accused the Congress government of exploiting their hard work. He claimed that the CM was making false statements about offering a 33% profit share to the workers. "Singareni's profits are Rs. 4701 crores, and if they are truly giving a 33% share, workers should be receiving a bonus of Rs. 1551 crores," KTR explained. He added that each worker should be getting Rs. 3.70 lakhs, but they are only being given Rs. 90,000. KTR demanded that Congress admit they are giving only a 16% bonus and called for the workers to be given Rs. 3.70 lakhs as a fair bonus.

KTR urged the AICUC (All India Coal Workers' Union) to respond to the reduction in the workers' share and called on Koonanneni Sambasivarao to express his opinion on the issue. He encouraged the Singareni workers to pressure Congress MLAs to increase their share, promising that BRS would stand by them.

# Harish Rao Criticizes Telangana Minister Over Yellampalli Project Credits

TPN, Telangana: Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) MLA T. Harish Rao strongly criticized Telangana BC Welfare Minister Ponnam Prabhakar on Sunday, September 22, for claiming credit for the completion of the Yellampalli project. Harish Rao, a senior BRS leader, stated that the Congress was overlooking the BRS government's significant role in completing and operationalizing the long-delayed Yellampalli project, which had been neglected

under previous Congress administrations.

Rao emphasized that while the Yellampalli barrage was officially declared complete, key aspects of the project, including the supply of water to farmers, had been ignored. "After the formation of Telangana, the BRS government swiftly completed construction of resettlement colonies, compensated flood victims, relocated people from flooded villages, and completed a high-level bridge on Rajiv Road. We also filled 20 TMCs of water in the Yellampalli reservoir up to Full Reservoir Level (FRL) of 148 meters," Harish Rao stated.

He further highlighted that the BRS govern-



ment had invested Rs 2,052 crore for land acquisition, rehabilitation, and infrastructure improvements, including the construction of high-level bridges and roads. Rao pointed out that Yellampalli became a key balancing reservoir for the Kaleshwaram project, which aimed to supply water to areas dependent on the reservoir.

In response to claims that the alignment of the project had changed, Harish

Rao clarified that the alignment from Yellampalli to Kondapochamma Sagar remained intact during re-engineering efforts. He added that the BRS government increased the storage capacity of the reservoirs as per recommendations from the Central Water Commission (CWC).

The original Pranahita-Chevella project proposed by the Congress had a total storage capacity of 14 TMC, while re-engineering efforts under BRS raised the capacity to 141 TMC. Rao concluded by emphasizing that the BRS government's efforts have led to tangible results, ensuring that water is now available for storage and use in the expanded reservoirs.

## KTR Afraid That Harish Rao Will Get the Position of Leader of Opposition

Telangana: Minister Komatireddy Venkatareddy has taken aim at the top leaders of BRS, claiming that KTR fears Harish Rao might attain the position of Leader of the Opposition—a prospect KCR does not support. He further explained that KTR is also competing for that post, adding that KTR is suffering from frus-

tration due to internal family disputes.

Komatireddy alleged that BRS lost the elections because of KTR's looting. He also accused Satyam Ramalinga Raju's son, known internationally, of being KTR's right-hand man in these alleged activities.

He warned that KTR is not a child and should think carefully before speaking. Komatireddy challenged KTR to present evidence of the Rs. 8,888 crore allocation linked to the Amrit tenders. He further alleged that KTR awarded tenders to a company owned by his benami, Satyam Ramalinga Raju's son, during the election code of conduct period.

Komatireddy also mentioned that they would soon reveal what Kavitha has done over the past ten years. He stated that both KTR and Harish Rao would definitely face jail time if former intelligence chief Prabhakar Rao were to return to the state and become an approver. As a result, Komatireddy accused KTR and Harish Rao of pressuring Prabhakar Rao to avoid returning to India from America.

## Bandi Sanjay Accuses Owaisi College Faculty of Terror Links

**TPN, Hyderabad:** On September 22, Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay claimed that a member of an internationally banned terrorist organization is employed at Fathima Owaisi College in Hyderabad.

Addressing the media, Sanjay alleged that an individual affiliated with Hizb ut-Tahrir, a globally recognized terrorist group, is working as faculty at the Owaisi-owned institution and is allegedly spreading extremist ideologies among students. He dismissed accusations of Islamophobia related to his earlier remarks.

Sanjay's controversial statements came shortly after Asaduddin Owaisi, the chief of the All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) and Hyderabad MP, criticized a recent statement made by BJP's Karimm

and Hyderabad MP, criticized a recent statement made by BJP's Karimnagar MP as Islamophobic.

The Union minister stirred further controversy by accusing madrasas of "fostering terrorism" and threatening national security. He claimed that some madrasas are instructing children



on how to use AK-47 rifles with brooms.

Owaisi responded on social media, urging every Indian to condemn Sanjay's communal remarks. Known for making statements that incite communal tension, Bandi Sanjay continues to polarize society with his comments.

**TPN**, **Hyderabad**: The National Investigation Agency (NIA) conducted inspections in Hyderabad today. NIA officials searched the Shankeshwar Bazar Green View Apartment in the Saidabad area, with inspections lasting for almost an hour.

It is known that the NIA arrested terrorist Rizwan Abdul in August. The NIA identified Rizwan as a wanted terrorist associated with the international terrorist organization ISIS. Rizwan Abdul was operating from Pune on behalf of ISIS.

Rizwan was detained at Delhi's Gangabakhsh Marg. During his arrest, a .30 bore

pistol, three cartridges, and two mobile phones were seized from him. A case has been registered against Rizwan at Delhi's Special Cell Police Station. There was already a reward of Rs. 3 lakh on Rizwan.

After his arrest in Delhi, the NIA took over the investigation. Based on information provided by Rizwan, the inspections were carried out in Hyderabad today. The NIA recently confirmed that Rizwan had been staying at Shankeshwar Green View Apartment in Saidabad for a few months. It is noteworthy that today's search was conducted to track Rizwan's movements.

#### IMD Hyderabad Issues Yellow Alert, Warns of Heavy Rains for the Next Three Days

Nampally in Hyderabad witnessed a significant surge in rainfall, recording 920.6 mm, up 61% from its normal average of 570.8 mm.

On Sunday, several areas in Telangana received heavy downpours, with Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district recording the highest rainfall at 103.3 mm. In Hyderabad, Golconda saw the heaviest rainfall at 91.3 mm.

#### **Hussain Sagar Reaches Capacity** After Heavy Rains in Hyderabad

TPN, Hyderabad: The heavy rains that lashed Hyderabad on Friday night and Saturday evening have led to significant inflows into Hussain Sagar Lake, causing the water level to rise to near capacity. According to the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC), the lake's water level reached 513.51 meters by 10:30 PM on Saturday, surpassing its full tank level of 513.41 meters.

## Plot to Blow Up Army Special Train Foiled in Madhya Pradesh

Madhya Pradesh: In a shocking incident in Burhanpur district, Madhya Pradesh, a plot to blow up a special train carrying army personnel was thwarted on Wednesday. Miscreants had planted 10 detonators on the railway track near Sagphata railway station. Fortunately, the conspiracy was foiled without any casualties, as one of the detonators went off, alerting the train driver, who immediately stopped the train, preventing a major disaster.

The special train, which was transporting army personnel from Jammu and Kashmir to Karnataka, was saved thanks to the quick response of the driver. Upon discovery, the driver promptly informed the station master, leading to the involvement of senior officials from the Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS), the National Investigation Agency (NIA), the Railways, and the local police. Investigations are underway, and authorities confirmed that no injuries were reported.

#### Gas Cylinder Found on Railway Track in Uttar Pradesh

In a separate incident in Uttar Pradesh, railway security personnel discovered a gas cylinder placed on the railway tracks near Prempur railway station in Kanpur early Sunday morning. The loco pilot of a goods train, traveling from Kanpur towards Prayagraj, applied emergency brakes to stop the train after spotting the cylinder at around 8:10 AM. Officials later confirmed that the 5 kg gas cylinder was empty.

This incident marks the second such occurrence in Uttar Pradesh this month, raising concerns about repeated attempts to sabotage railway infrastructure. Authorities are investigating the circumstances surrounding both incidents to determine whether they are part of a larger conspiracy targeting rail operations.

The discovery of detonators and a gas cylinder on railway tracks within such a short time frame has heightened suspicions of coordinated efforts to cause train accidents across the country. Security agencies are on high alert as investigations continue.

## The Quad and India's Role in It: Staying Relevant Amid China's Rise

The Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (Quad), comprising the United States, India, Japan, and Australia, has now been around for nearly two decades. First conceptualized in 2004 following the Indian Ocean tsunami, the Quad has, at times, faced skepticism over its relevance and purpose. Despite such uncertainty, the Quad has gradually solidified its place in international diplomacy, especially in the Indo-Pacific region, a development driven, in no small part, by the growing influence of China.

At the fourth Quad leaders' summit in Wilmington, Delaware, US President Joe Biden was asked about the future of the Quad. His confident response, "Much beyond that," indicated the Quad's staying power despite challenges. #### **AUKUS** and Quad: **Complementary or Competing?**

The relevance of the Quad came under scrutiny in 2021 with the formation of AUKUS, a trilateral security pact between Australia, the United Kingdom, and the United States. AUKUS, with its military-focused agenda, immediately raised concerns that it might overshadow the Quad, which lacks a direct military component. Comparisons between the two partnerships intensified, leading some to question whether the Quad could effectively counter China's growing influence in the Indo-Pacific.

India and Australia were initially hesitant about the Quad's re-emergence in 2017, concerned about antagonizing China. India shares a long, tense border with China, while Australia has deep economic ties to Beijing. Both nations were wary of appearing to align with a perceived US-led initiative to "contain" China. However, the situation shifted dramatically in 2020. India's border conflict with China in Eastern Ladakh and Australia's trade disputes with Beijing led both countries to shed their reservations about the Quad.

In 2020, India took the initiative to push for a standalone Quad ministerial meeting in Tokyo, marking a significant shift in the Quad's trajectory. With India and Australia more firmly on board, the Quad began to grow beyond its tentative begin-

The Quad's involvement in such economic initiatives demonstrates its value beyond military confrontation, focusing on strategic competition in the economic sphere, particularly against China.

Another significant Quad initiative was the \*\*Quad Vaccine Partnership\*\*, launched in 2021. This effort delivered 400 million COVID-19 vaccine doses to Indo-Pacific nations, providing a counterweight to China's extensive vaccine diplomacy in the region. China had distributed nearly 900 million doses to Asia-Pacific countries by December 2022, according to Bridge Consulting, a firm that tracks China's global health influence. The Quad's vaccine efforts served to reduce China's sway in these nations, reflecting the partnership's potential to exert influence through soft power.

#### India's Crucial Role in the **Quad's Relevance**

India's involvement in the Quad adds

unique value to the partnership, making it more strategically important, especially for the US. While AUKUS is a purely Western alliance, extend its influence beyond traditional Western spheres.

Political theorist John Ikenberry's "Three Worlds" framework helps explain India's significance. According to Ikenberry, the global West (led by the US) and the global East (dominated by China and Russia) are in competition to shape the world order. The global South, in this context, represents a "swing grouping" capable of aligning with either side. India, as a prominent leader of the global South, holds a pivotal role in balancing world politics. By participating in the Quad, India can tilt the dynamics of global alliances and exert influence over the international order.

India's inclusion makes the Quad a more comprehensive and globally relevant partnership. Its geopolitical position, economic power, and influence in the Global South contribute to shaping the Indo-Pacific region's security and economic framework, making the Quad an essential component of the US-led efforts to maintain a rules-based international or-

#### Kolkata's Iconic Trams: The 151-Year-Old Legacy on the **Brink of Extinction**

The dinging bell of a tram rattling through the crowded streets of Kolkata brings a sense of nostalgia to many, including 18-year-old Deep Das. "There were times when buses were frequent, but I still waited for the trams," the student says, recalling the happiest moments of his day spent on this iconic transport. For Kolkata's residents, trams are more than just a mode of travel; they are a symbol of the city's rich history. But this 151-year-old network, once the pride of the eastern metropolis, is now facing a slow but steady decline.



Introduced in 1873, when Kolkata was still a jewel in the British Empire's crown, the trams were initially horse- The West Bengal Transport Corporation tioned to steam-driven and finally electric-powered trams by 1900. The sight of these blue-and-white striped vehicles, with a sunshine-yellow top, weaving through the city streets was once a familiar one. But today, they are an endangered relic.

Kolkata is the only city in India that still has an operational tram system, a fact that adds to its historic value. However, this unique distinction is now under threat, with the network gradually shrinking due to a combination of neglect, modern urban challenges, and shifting priorities.

#### A Struggle for Survival

Deep Das is not alone in his efforts to save the trams. He is part of the Calcutta Tram Users' Association (CTUA), a group of tram enthusiasts dedicated to preserving this heritage transport. Led by retired biochemist Debashish Bhattacharyya, the CTUA is fighting to keep the trams alive, arguing that city authorities are overlooking their potential.

Bhattacharyya believes that trams are not just a historical asset but also an environmentally friendly and economical solution to Kolkata's modern transportation problems. "The investment required is minimum," Bhattacharyya says. He points out that the lifespan of a tram is 50 to 80 years, far longer than the 5 to 10 years of a typical bus, and that their operational costs are much lower.

#### An Old Glory in Modern Times

The slow-moving trams are still a beloved part of Kolkata's landscape. They crawl through the city at about 20 km/h, navigating the traffic-clogged roads filled with vintage yellow taxis, buses, and even cattle. Yet, the tram lines often seem neglected; some parts of the infrastructure have been repur-



posed for makeshift laundry lines, with clothes fluttering in the breeze.

> A ride on the tram costs a mere seven rupees, less than the price of a cup of tea, and far cheaper than a bus ride. However, the trams run on such irregular schedules that many commuters prefer to pay more for a bus or taxi in order to be on time.

#### **Nostalgia Meets Reality**

For many older residents, a ride on the tram is a trip down memory lane. Ram Singh, a 54-year-old teacher, recalls the trams of his youth. "We used to ride trams, and get off after one or two stops. Then we would get on the tram from the other side and get off again, without paying for a ticket," he says with a chuckle.

But this once-extensive network has dwindled to just two operational lines, a shadow of its former self. At one depot, dozens of tram cars sit derelict, their vibrant colors swallowed by rust, some dating back to the 1940s. "Cities should develop, but along with it, history should also be preserved," Singh says, lamenting that the trams represent Kolkata's "old identity."

#### A Fight for the Future

Das and his group continue to hold community meetings, put up posters, and campaign to raise awareness about the tram system's plight. However, their work also includes tracking breakdowns and addressing the system's many technical challenges. Each malfunction serves as a reminder that the trams may not have much





# Free, Open Indo-Pacific Is Our Shared Priority: Modi At Quad Summit

At the Quad summit in Wilmington, Prime Minister Narendra Modi declared that "the Quad is here to stay," emphasizing a collective commitment to a free, open, and inclusive Indo-Pacific. Joined by U.S. President Joe Biden, Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese, and Japanese Prime Minister Fumio Kishida, Modi highlighted the summit's significance amid global tensions.

In his opening remarks, Modi stressed the importance of shared democratic values among Quad members, stating, "We are not against anybody." He reinforced their dedication to a rules-based international order that respects sovereignty and promotes peaceful conflict resolution. "A free, open, inclusive, and prosperous Indo-Pacific is our shared priority," he asserted.

Modi noted the Quad's positive initiatives in various sectors, including health security, emerging technologies, climate change, and capacity building. "Our message is clear— the Quad is here to stay, to assist, to partner, and to complement," he stated, proposing to host the next Quad Leaders' Summit in India in 2025.



He also praised President Biden's leadership, acknowledging the first Quad summit under his tenure and the enhanced cooperation among member nations. "I express my heartfelt gratitude to you for your firm commitment and contribution towards the Quad," Modi said.

Earlier in the day, Modi arrived in the U.S. for a three-day visit, where he held fruitful bilateral talks with Biden at the president's Delaware residence. During his trip, Modi is also set to address the Summit of the Future at the UN General Assembly in New York and engage with Indian expatriates and American business leaders.



#### Where There Is No Devotion: Sadhguru On Tirupati Laddoo Row

Amid the controversy over alleged animal fat in Tirupati Laddu, spiritual leader Sadhguru Jaggi Vasudev expressed strong disapproval, stating that the inclusion of beef tallow in temple 'prasadam' is "beyond disgusting." He emphasized the importance of temples being managed by devotees rather than government administrations, asserting, "Where there is no Devotion, there shall be no sanctity."

The uproar began after Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu alleged on September 18 that the current government under Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy was using animal fat and substandard ingredients in the preparation of Tirupati laddus. He claimed that even the sacred laddu was compromised with inferior materials, contrasting it with previous standards when it was made with pure ghee.

In response, YSRCP MP and former Chairman of the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD) Y. V. Subba Reddy refuted Naidu's claims, insisting that TTD only uses pure cow ghee and organic ingredients for the 'prasadam.'

The situation intensified as former Congress leader Acharya Pramod Krishnam labeled the issue a "dangerous conspiracy" aimed at undermining Sanatan Dharma. Protests ensued from the Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha (BJYM), the youth wing of the BJP, demanding an apology from Reddy over the controversy.



#### Nitish Kumar Requests Vande Bharat Train for Ayodhya-Sitamarhi Route

Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has formally requested Prime Minister Narendra Modi to introduce a Vande Bharat train connecting Ayodhya and Sitamarhi, enhancing rail connectivity for pilgrims visiting these holy towns. The request comes as the Bihar government develops Punaura Dham Janki Mandir in Sitamarhi, regarded as the birthplace of Goddess Sita.

In his letter, Kumar highlighted the significance of improved rail services for the numerous pilgrims who visit both Ram Mandir in Ayodhya and Punaura Dham Janki Mandir daily. He acknowledged the central government's recent efforts to introduce multiple Vande Bharat trains in Bihar and expressed gratitude for these initiatives.

Kumar also mentioned the ongoing construction of the "Ram-Janki Marg" project, which aims to facilitate better road access between Ayodhya and Sitamarhi. He urged the Ministry of Railways to prioritize the new train service to further ease travel for devotees.

The state government has allocated ₹72.47 crore for the overall development of Punaura Dham, which includes plans for creating amenities like 'Sita-Vatika,' 'Luv-Kush Vatilka,' and recreational areas for children. Additional infrastructure improvements, such as thematic gates and parking spaces, are also underway to enhance the pilgrimage experience.

With these developments, the Bihar government aims to bolster religious tourism in the region and improve the facilities available to thousands of visitors who flock to Punaura Dham annually.

# Kejriwal Challenges RSS and Modi

AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal launched a bold political strategy on Sunday, directly questioning the RSS and Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership at a rally in Delhi. By implying that the RSS should rein in its "child," Kejriwal sought to diminish Modi's stature, asking, "Has the son become so big now that it is showing attitude to his mother?"

At his first 'Janta ki Adalat' public meeting since resigning as Delhi chief minister, Kejriwal posed five pointed questions to RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat. He questioned the RSS's stance on the BJP's alleged misuse of central agencies to destabilize opposition parties and the practice of inducting "corrupt" leaders into the party.

Kejriwal specifically referenced the BJP's retirement age rule, which he claimed was applied to senior leaders like LK Advani but



exempted Modi. He challenged Bhagwat by asking if he agreed that this inconsistency undermined the credibility of the party's leadership.

While Kejriwal addressed his supporters at Jantar Mantar, the BJP organized protests against him nearby, focusing on corruption allegations. AAP supporters, however, rallied around Kejriwal, displaying ban-

ners affirming his integrity and chanting slogans in his support.

Kejriwal, recently released on bail after over five months in Tihar Jail related to an excise policy case, emphasized that his political journey was driven by a desire to serve rather than seek power. He expressed his hurt over the corruption allegations and claimed that he had earned respect rather than wealth during his decade in politics.

As he prepares for the upcoming Delhi Assembly elections, Kejriwal described the contest as an "agni pariksha" (trial by fire) and urged voters to reconsider their support if they believed he was dishonest. He announced plans to relocate from the chief minister's residence after the Navratri period, opting to live among the people who have supported him.



#### Uday Bhanu Chib Appointed President of Indian Youth Congress

Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge has appointed Uday Bhanu Chib as the new President of the Indian Youth Congress, effective immediately. Chib, previously serving as the General Secretary of the Indian Youth Congress and former President of the Jammu & Kashmir Pradesh Youth Congress, is recognized for his significant contributions to the party. The Congress party expressed appreciation for the outgoing president, Srinivas BV.

Uday Bhanu Chib has also been involved in the Congress manifesto committee for the upcoming J&K Assembly elections. He recently met with senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi in New Delhi, discussing strategies and party initiatives.

#### Mayawati Raises Alarm Over Rising Crimes Against Women

#### **India Pledges** \$7.5 Million to **Combat Cervical** Cancer in Indo-**Pacific Region**

Washington: In a significant move to strengthen the fight against cervical cancer, India has pledged USD 7.5 million towards cancer testing, screening, and diagnosis in the Indo-Pacific region. The announcement was made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during the Cancer Moonshot event, hosted by US President Joe Biden on the sidelines of the Quad Leaders' Summit in Delaware.

The initiative, part of the Quad Cancer Moonshot, is a "groundbreaking partnership" aimed at saving lives by addressing gaps in cervical cancer care in the Indo-Pacific region. The Quad, comprising India, the US, Japan, and Australia, has committed to working together to improve access to cervical cancer treatment and screening.

Modi highlighted that the grant is part of India's broader vision of \*'One Earth, One Health,'\* and reiterated India's willingness to share its expertise in healthcare. As part of this initiative, India will also provide radiotherapy treatment and capacity-building support for cancer prevention in the region.

In addition to the cancer initiative, India will supply 40 million doses of vaccines through GAVI and Quad programs to support healthcare efforts in the Indo-Pacific. Modi emphasized the Quad's people-centric approach, stating, "When the Quad acts, it is not just for nations, it is for the people."

The White House fact sheet issued on Saturday underscored the importance of the Quad Cancer Moonshot in strengthening cancer-care infrastructure, expanding research collaborations, and improving access to cervical cancer screening and treatment. Currently, cervical cancer remains the third leading cause of cancer deaths among women in the region, with fewer than 10% of women having completed their HPV vaccinations.

The Quad nations will collaborate with UN agencies to lower the costs of HPV diagnostics and work with the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) to improve medical imaging and radiation therapy access in underserved areas.

## **US Supports India's Bid for Permanent UN Security Council Seat at Quad Summit**

Wilmington: During the recent Quad Leaders Summit, US President Joe Biden expressed strong support for India's inclusion as a permanent member of a reformed United Nations Security Council (UNSC). The summit, attended by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Japan's PM Fumio Kishida, and Australian PM Anthony Albanese, highlighted efforts to expand UNSC membership in both permanent and non-permanent categories.

In a joint statement, the Quad leaders emphasized the importance of reforming global institutions to reflect modern geopolitical realities, with Biden commending India's leadership, particularly Modi's role in the G-20 and Global South. India's large population, growing economy, and active involvement in international peacekeeping make it a strong candidate for permanent membership, a cause it has long championed.

The Quad leaders reaffirmed their commitment to ensuring freedom of navigation and securing maritime routes, particularly in the Middle East. India is set to assume co-leadership of the Combined Task Force 150 in 2025 to safeguard sea lanes in the Arabian Sea.

Prime Minister Modi also reiterated the Quad's commitment to a "free, open, inclusive, and prosperous Indo-Pacific." He outlined several initiatives aimed at addressing global chal-



lenges, including health security, emerging technologies, and climate change. Modi described the Quad as a "force for global good."

On the economic front, the US announced a \$1 billion multilateral financing plan for clean energy projects in India, while Modi unveiled a \$7.5 million grant for cancer screening in the Indo-Pacific as part of India's "One Earth, One Health" vision.

Additionally, the US and India expanded cooperation in technology and defense, including the development of semiconductor manufacturing and unmanned surface vehicle systems.

This deepening partnership reflects the growing strategic importance of the India-US relationship in global security, technology, and economic development.

#### **PM Modi Gifts Silver Train** Model, Pashmina Shawl to Joe and Jill Biden



Wilmington, Delaware: Prime Minister Narendra Modi, during his three-day visit to the US, presented US President Joe Biden with a handcrafted antique silver train model as a token of friendship. The meeting took place in Biden's hometown, Wilmington, ahead of the Quad Leaders' Summit.

The silver train model, inscribed with "DELHI-DELAWARE" on the main carriage and "INDIAN RAILWAYS" on the engine in both English and Hindi, was crafted by artisans from Maharashtra, renowned for their expertise in silver craftsmanship. The model is made of 92.5% silver and represents the cultural and historical ties between India and the US. Additionally, PM Modi gifted a Kashmiri pashmina shawl to First Lady Jill Biden, symbolizing the rich cultural heritage of India.

The meeting between Modi and Biden was described as "extremely fruitful," with discussions focusing on enhancing bilateral cooperation in areas of mutual interest. The two leaders also exchanged views on global and regional issues, particularly in the Indo-Pacific region. PM Modi shared on social media platform X, expressing gratitude for the warm reception, stating, "I thank President Biden for hosting me at his residence in Greenville, Delaware. Our talks were extremely fruitful."

President Biden also posted on X, highlighting the strength of the India-US partnership, calling it "stronger, closer, and more dynamic than any time in history."



#### **297 Indian Antiquities Returned During PM Modi's Visit to the US**

New Delhi: In a significant diplomatic achievement, the United States returned 297 antiquities to India during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's recent visit, bringing the total number of repatriated artefacts to 640 since 2014. This move highlights India's continued efforts to combat the illicit trafficking of cultural property and recover its lost heritage.

The US has become a key partner in India's recovery mission, having returned a total of 578 antiquities to date. Notably, between 2004 and 2013, only one artefact was returned to India. This marks substantial progress in India's efforts under PM Modi's leadership, particularly after the return of 157 antiquities during his 2021 visit, including a 12th-century bronze Nataraja statue. Earlier in 2023, another 105 artefacts were repatriated, underscoring the sustained effort to reclaim India's stolen cultural treasures.

India's recovery efforts are not limited to the US. The country has successfully retrieved 16 artefacts from the United Kingdom and 40 from Australia, as part of a broader strategy to preserve its rich cultural heritage.

A major milestone in these efforts was the signing of the \*Cultural Property Agreement\* between India and the US in July 2024, during the 46th World Heritage Committee meeting in New Delhi. This agreement aims to prevent further trafficking of Indian antiquities to the US and strengthens both nations' commitment to protecting cultural heritage.

#### India Investigates Netflix for Visa **Violations and Racial Discrimination**

New Delhi: India is investigating Netflix's business practices, including allegations of visa violations, tax evasion, and racial discrimination, according to a government email sent to a former company executive. The investigation was revealed in a July 20 email from Deepak Yadav, an official with India's Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO), to Nandini Mehta, Netflix's former director of business and legal affairs for India. Reuters reviewed the email, which outlines the concerns about Netflix's operations in the country.

The email mentions "visa violation, illegal structures, tax evasion, and incidents of racial discrimination" linked to Netflix's business conduct in India. The probe is reportedly part of increasing scrutiny of the US streaming giant, which has approximately 10 million users in India, a key growth market.

Ms. Mehta, who left Netflix in 2020, is currently suing the company in the US for wrongful termination, racial, email statement, she welcomed the Indian investigation and expressed hope that the findings would be made public. However, Netflix denies the allegations, stating that Ms. Mehta was fired for misusing her corporate try of Home Affairs. credit card for personal expenses.



## WhatsApp Beta Rolls Out Feature to Block Unknown Account **Messages**

WhatsApp is rolling out an update for beta testers that introduces a new feature aimed at protecting users from unwanted messages sent by unknown accounts. This feature, which is already available to some testers, automatically filters out messages under specific circumstances and must be manually enabled by users.

With the update to WhatsApp beta for Android version 2.24.20.16, users can access the new setting by navigating to the three-dot menu, then selecting Settings > Privacy > Advanced > Block unknown account messages. This toggle allows users to block messages from unidentified accounts that exceed a certain volume, thereby reducing the influx of spam and protecting device performance.

WhatsApp describes the feature as a means to enhance user security while improving overall device performance. By blocking messages from unknown accounts that reach a specified threshold, the messaging platform aims to mitigate the negative impact of spam on users' devices. However, users will still be able to receive messages from unknown accounts up to an unspecified limit, which WhatsApp has not disclosed to prevent spammers from circumventing the feature.

Currently, this privacy feature is limited to beta tes-



ters, meaning that users on the stable update channel will need to wait for a broader rollout in the future. As WhatsApp continues to enhance its privacy settings, this feature represents one of several "advanced" options designed to safeguard user accounts and enhance the overall messaging experience.

## Mumbai Woman Duped of ₹3.37 Lakh by Tinder Scam



A43-year-old woman in Mumbai fell victim to a scam, losing ₹3.37 lakh after befriending a man on the dating app Tinder. The woman, an art director, met a person named 'Advait' last month, and they began exchanging messages.

Advait claimed he was abroad and would arrive in Mumbai on September 16 to meet her. On the scheduled

date, she received a call from someone posing as a Delhi customs official, who informed her that Advait had been detained at the airport with thousands of Euros.

The caller pressured her to pay ₹3.37 lakh via UPI to secure Advait's release. Believing the story, she complied. Subsequently, the caller requested an additional ₹4.99 lakh to

further assist with the situation.

While attempting to transfer the additional funds at her bank, a vigilant bank official noticed her distress and alerted her to the possibility of a scam, prompting her to report the incident. A case of cheating has since been registered at the Versova police station, and authorities are investigating the matter.

This incident adds to a troubling trend of dating app scams, with a recent case involving a 33-year-old woman from Malad, who was defrauded of ₹2.45 lakh by a man posing as a doctor from the UK, claiming he was also caught up with customs issues.

Authorities are warning users of dating apps to be cautious and vigilant about sharing personal information and sending money to individuals they meet online.

#### Beatriz Haddad Maia Triumphs Over Daria Kasatkina at Korea Open

Brazil's Beatriz Haddad Maia staged a remarkable comeback to clinch her fourth career title, defeating top seed Daria Kasatkina in the Korea Open final with a score of 1-6, 6-4, 6-1. The match, held in Seoul, saw Haddad Maia, seeded third, lose the first set in just 26 minutes but rally to take control in the following sets, ultimately securing her first title since June 2022.

After the match, Haddad Maia reflected on her performance, saying, "I know that tennis changes everything very fast. I was competing better at the end of the second set, and then my tennis appeared. I finished in the way that I wanted, and I think I deserved this win."

For Kasatkina, ranked 13th in the world, the loss marked her fourth defeat in five finals this year. She expressed the difficulty of losing in the final, stating, "It's tough, especially being up in the final, but she definitely raised the level after the first set."

Both players had reached the final without dropping a set, despite facing challenges when heavy rain canceled matches the day before. Kasatkina's route included a quarter-final victory against Emma Raducanu, who retired due to injury.

Kasatkina broke Haddad Maia twice early on, establishing a solid lead in the first set. However, the momentum shifted in the second when



Haddad Maia began to find her rhythm. After breaking back, she took the lead and managed to close out the set despite a dispute with the umpire.

In the final set, Haddad Maia quickly gained the upper hand, breaking Kasatkina again and finishing the match when Kasatkina's return went long. "I feel stronger; I feel that I'm very competitive now," said Haddad Maia, looking ahead to the remainder of the season.

The Korea Open, a WTA 500 tournament for the first time, faced several withdrawals, including top-ranked players like Iga Swiatek and Jessica Pegula, but ultimately showcased an exciting final.

# India Makes History with Double Gold at Chess Olympiad 2024

India achieved a remarkable milestone by winning gold in both the men's and women's categories at the 45th Chess Olympiad 2024. This historic achievement came after the final matches on Sunday, where both teams displayed exceptional skill and determination.

The men's team secured their gold by defeating Slovenia, with standout performances from D Gukesh, Arjun Erigaisi, and R Praggnanadhaa, each winning their respective matches in the decisive 11th round. # India Makes History with Test Victory Over Bangladesh in Chennai

India has made cricketing history by securing their 179th Test victory, achieving a milestone that sees their wins surpass their losses for the first time since their inaugural Test match in 1932. The team triumphed over Bangladesh in the first Test of a two-match series in Chennai, winning by 280 runs.

This historic win at Chepauk allows India to have a win-loss record of 179 wins to 178 losses, following a total of 581 Test matches played. The Indian team has long been in pursuit of this achievement since their first Test under captain CK Naidu, where they lost to England by 158 runs. Now, India joins the ranks of other cricketing nations with a positive win-loss ratio, including Australia, England, South Africa, and Pakistan.

Najmul Hossain Shanto top-scored for Bangladesh with an impressive 82 runs.

This victory not only highlights India's prowess in Test cricket but also marks a significant turning point in their cricketing history, reinforcing their status as a formidable force in the longest format of the game. As they lead the series 1-0, anticipation builds for the second Test, where India aims to continue their historic run.

# Mohun Bagan Super Giant Aims for First Win Against NorthEast United

"They will be eager to overcome us, and our job is to make it as tough as possible," he said, expressing confidence in his players' readiness.

# Eoin Morgan: Harry Brook's Captaincy a "Baptism of Fire" After Loss to Australia

Following England's second consecutive loss to Australia in the ODI series, former World Cup-winning captain Eoin Morgan described Harry Brook's captaincy as a "baptism of fire." In the latest match at Headingley, Australia defeated England by 68 runs, marking their 14th straight ODI victory and showcasing their dominance in the format.

Morgan noted some positives from the game, particularly highlighting the batting performance in the earlier match at Trent Bridge, where Ben Duckett and Will Jacks formed a solid partnership. However, he pointed out that England's bowlers lacked the consistency shown by the Australians. "They weren't as consistent as Australia would have been if they had bowled first, but that comes with experience and skill," Morgan explained.

He emphasized that Brook is facing a challenging introduction to captaincy, given the strength of the Australian side and the heavy defeats England has suffered. Morgan predicted that the ODI squad could see significant changes for upcoming tours, including the India series and the ICC Champions Trophy next year. Key players like Ben Stokes, Jofra Archer, Mark Wood, and Joe Root might return, which could shift the dynamics of the team.

In the recent match, England initially looked promising after reducing Australia to 89/3. However, Mitchell Marsh and Alex Carey played crucial innings, with Carey scoring 74 runs and



aiding Australia in recovering to post a total of 270. England struggled in response, finding themselves at 65/5 due to the Australian pacers' relentless pressure, before some lower-order resilience helped them reach a more respectable score.

The next ODI is scheduled for September 24 at Chester-le-Street, where Australia will aim to solidify their position at the top of the ODI rankings.


