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Govt Aims to Boost State Budget to ₹7 Lakh Crore: CM



TPN, Hyderabad: Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy announced on Wednesday, September 25, that his government is committed to increasing the state's budget from the current ₹3 lakh crore to ₹7 lakh crore within the next four years. He emphasized the state's goal of becoming a USD one trillion economy.

Speaking at the launch of a skill develop-

ment programme in the BFSI (Banking, Financial Services and Insurance) sector, the chief minister outlined his vision for Telangana to compete globally, rather than focusing on competition with other Indian states or cities like Andhra Pradesh, Bengaluru, or Chennai.

Highlighting Hyderabad's prominence in the tech industry, he noted that world-renowned leaders such as Satya Nadella, Shantanu Narayen, and World Bank president Ajay Banga, all alumni of Hyderabad Public School (HPS), could play a key role in supporting the state's initiatives. During his recent visit to the US, Reddy invited these influential personalities to return to Hyderabad in December to assist the state's efforts, including the establishment of a skills university.

A Vision for Hyderabad's Global Competitiveness

Reddy discussed Hyderabad's role as a major employment hub, driven by the IT revolution, and stressed the importance of enhancing the city's global brand image by attracting prestigious universities. He reiterated his belief that Telangana must "compete with the world," positioning Hyderabad as a global center for innovation and technical expertise.

With over 50% of India's population being youth, Reddy said the focus should be on providing the technical expertise needed to drive economic growth. "Hyderabad should emerge as the hub to provide that expertise," he said.

Revanth Reddy's Warning to Educational Institutions on one lakh engineering graduates come out of colleges every year in the state, but some do not even have basic knowledge in certain areas. The reason for that is that teaching staff and others in those colleges are not up to the mark," said Reddy. He warned that the government would revoke the permissions of colleges that fail to meet the required standards.

In response to incidents involving engineering students and other college attendees being caught selling narcotics such as ganja, the Chief Minister emphasized the need for stricter measures to curb this menace. He condemned those in public life who indirectly support the guilty and called for decisive government action to tackle the issue.

CONGRESS PLANNED TO USE PJR'S IMAGE FOR GHMC

TPN, Telangana: The Congress party has set its sights on Greater Hyderabad and is determined to secure the GHMC chairmanship in the upcoming elections. As part of its strategy, the party is considering whom to bring closer and whom to appoint to key positions. A significant focus is on new recruitments. Recently, Khairatabad MLA Danam Nagender brought Arikepudi Gandhi into the party, and efforts are underway to attract a few more.

The Congress party's organizational strength in Greater Hyderabad is currently very weak. While there is competition for party tickets, it has been lagging in securing votes. There are 24 constituencies under Greater Hyderabad, and although there was competition for tickets in all of them, the party failed to win a single seat. Some members accepted the leadership's decisions, while others defected to different parties. Despite the Congress having an impact at the state level, it has not been able to make its presence felt in Greater Hyderabad. To overcome this situation, the party has already started its efforts.

history by becoming the first city in India to achieve 100 percent sewage treatment, marking a significant milestone in the rejuvenation of the Musi River. Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president KT Rama Rao (KTR) made the announcement during his visit to a completed Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) in Fatehnagar, Kukatpally, on Wednesday, September 25.

Providing details of the project, KTR noted that it was initiated by the previous BRS government, aiming to transform Hyderabad into a city free from dirty water. The project involves the construction of 31 STPs with a total treatment capacity of 1,259.50

TPN, Hyderabad: Hyderabad is set to make MLD (million liters per day) at a cost of ₹3,866 crore.

> KTR highlighted the significance of these plants, saying, "Once completed, these STPs will treat the sewage water of the entire city of Hyderabad."

> The 31 STPs are spread across various locations, including Durgam Cheruvu, Kokapet, Miralam Site-I, Pedda Cheruvu, Nalla Cheruvu-1, Miyapur-Patelcheruvu, Safilguda, Nagole, Khajakunta, Fathenagar-1, Vennelagadda, Nallagandla, Mullakathuwa Cheruvu, Shivalaya Nagar, Palapitta Park, Attapur-1, Ramacheruvu, Rainbow Vista, Attapur-2, and Amberpet.

Speaking to reporters after his visit, KTR reiterated that the BRS government launched this initiative to make Hyderabad a city free from sewage-related issues. However, he expressed concern that progress had slowed after the Congress government came to power, urging for its swift completion.

KTR also questioned the current government's prioritization of the project. "What is the need to treat closed water again when the water treated by these STPs is still going unused? The government should give more priority to this program to relieve the people of Hyderabad from dirty water and strive to complete it as soon as possible," he said.

This time, the Congress is considering giving more importance to leaders from Greater Hyderabad in the distribution of party positions. Party leaders have indicated that they want to give opportunities to strong leaders in the PCC committee. They believe that if the position of Working President, which is the second most crucial role after the party president, is given to a leader from Greater Hyderabad, it could strengthen the party and help secure the GHMC.

There is talk within the party that some leaders have suggested giving the Working President position to Vijay Reddy, daughter of PJR, under the women's quota. They believe that this could bolster the party's strength, as Vijay Reddy can leverage her father's strong image. It is rumored that the high command is considering this suggestion. Some senior leaders have already appealed to the high command for priority in the PCC, and former Mayor Bonthu Rammohan is also vying for the position. Having hoped for a Congress ticket in the recent Assembly elections, Bonthu Rammohan is now competing for the Working President role.

Meanwhile, several leaders have been lobbying with incharge Deepadas Munshi and PCC President Mahesh Goud. However, as Vijay Reddy, with her stronghold in Greater Hyderabad, is in touch with key leaders, it seems that the high command is leaning towards her. Party leaders believe that assigning her this responsibility could further strengthen the Congress. Overall, it remains to be seen whether the Congress will capitalize on PJR's legacy.

Govt Strengthens HYDRA with New Staff Allocation

TPN, Telangana: The government has taken steps to strengthen the Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring Protection (HYDRA) by allocating 169 personnel, issuing a Government Order (GO) for the same. The new team includes an IPS-rank officer, a cadre-level SP officer, three non-cadre SPs, and five DSP-rank officers. Additionally, 16 Circle Inspectors (CIs) and inspectors, as well as three Tahsildars, have been assigned to support the initiative.

The objective is to enhance HYDRA's capabilities in handling disaster response and protecting public assets. Alongside police personnel, revenue officers have also been allocated to the organization to ensure comprehensive coordination between different departments.

During the event, CM Reddy outlined plans to fill an additional 35,000 vacancies in the next two to three months, aiming to enhance employment opportunities for the youth. The BFSI skill training program is part of this initiative, designed to equip participants with essential skills for success in the banking, financial services, and insurance sectors. This program is specifically tailored to ensure students can secure employment immediately after completing

their training. The government has collaborated with industry experts to develop an action plan based on proposals from the BFSI sector, intending to create a skilled workforce that meets industry needs.

Reddy also announced plans to upgrade 65 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) into Advanced Technology Centers in partnership with Tata Technologies over the next two years. Additionally, the government will focus on strengthening engineering colleges, warning that institutions failing to meet minimum educational standards will face revocation of their permissions.

Despite these efforts, Reddy acknowledged that unemployment remains a challenge, with over three lakh students graduating from professional institutions each year.

Nearly 2,600 MBA Seats Vacant in Telangana After Final Phase Seat Allotment

TPN, Telangana: In Telangana, a total of 2,598 MBA seats remain vacant following the final phase of seat allotment for the 2024-25 academic year. The Telangana Integrated Common Entrance Test (TG ICET) 2024 concluded with only 25,747 of the 28,345 available seats in 266 MBA colleges being filled.

The lack of interest among students in management programs is evident, as even university campuses and constituent colleges saw unallocated seats. Specifically, 65 out of 1,639 seats in 21 colleges were left vacant. The highest number of unfilled seats, totaling 2,529, was found in 243 private management colleges. In contrast, two private universities experienced a significant achievement, with 97.8% of their 184 available seats filled.

MCA admissions mirrored this trend, with 871 seats remaining unallocated across 89 colleges. Most of these vacant seats—855—were in 74 private institutions, alongside 16 unallocated seats in 15 university colleges.

According to the Technical Education Department, 71,647 candidates qualified for the TG ICET 2024, but only 39,647 had their certificates verified. Ultimately, 22,153 students exercised web options for seat allotment. For MBA programs, 25,747 seats were released for candidates participating in web-based counseling. Similarly, for the MCA program, out of 6,966 available seats, 6,095 were allotted, with 99 colleges achieving 100% seat allotments.



Kaleswaram Commission Inquiry Concludes

TPN, Telangana: The inquiry into the Kaleswaram project has concluded, with key officials appearing before the commission today. Former Chief Accounts Officer of Kaleswaram Corporation, Venkata Apparao; Irrigation Chief Accounts Officer, Padmavathi; and Works and Accounts Director, Manibhushan Sharma, attended the session. Kaleswaram Corporation MD & ENC, Hari Ram, and Medigadda SC, Sardar Omkar Singh, are also expected to participate in today's hearing.

The commission posed several questions to the officials, particularly regarding the basis on which loans were secured. The officials explained that the corporation would only take out loans after obtaining approval from the government, as directed by the Secretary of the Irrigation Department.

Venkata Apparao noted that they had taken loans from NABARD, referencing that Rajat Kumar was the Irrigation Secretary at the time. Irrigation Secretary at the time. water to Ramagundam and NTPC.



When PC Ghosh inquired about the assets available to secure large loans, the accounts officers admitted they did not possess any assets. They clarified that assets would only be available upon the completion of the Kaleswaram project.

Revanth Reddy has agreed to proceed with the caste census, and the Chief Minister is on board with this plan. However, whenever the topic of caste is discussed, BRS criticizes it, while the BJP opposes the caste census. The BJP claims that having a BC Prime Minister means justice has been served to the BC community. Mahesh Kumar challenged BRS, questioning whether they could change their party president to a BC leader.

He stated that the caste census for BCs is the Congress party's patent right, an idea originating from Rahul Gandhi. Mahesh Kumar assured that the Chief Minister will follow Rahul Gandhi's directives regarding this matter.

Mallareddy further revealed that his colleges were constructed during the Congress regime, emphasizing that it is unfair to demolish houses and force people onto the streets. Mallareddy alleged that Hydra is harassing the people of Telangana and criticized its use as a tool to divert public attention from more pressing issues. He questioned the need to demolish homes and displace people, accusing the Congress of failing to fulfill its election promises. "They are demolishing houses as if some sort of war is happen-



ing in Telangana," he said.

He also attacked Congress leaders, accusing them of making it their mission to insult Telangana Chief Minister KCR and IT Minister KTR. Mallareddy challenged the Congress government, saying that if they can produce more crops than during KCR's rule, they would be rewarded. He criticized the lack of support for farmers under Revanth Reddy's leadership, citing an incomplete loan waiver and a general lack of assurance for the farming community. He also commented on the lack of unity within Congress ministers, further questioning their ability to govern effectively.

He directed the BC Commission to conduct a thorough study and initiate the BC census, urging its swift completion.

If necessary, the CM suggested visiting other states to review their procedures. He assured the commission that the government would fully cooperate in completing the BC caste census quickly. The members of the commission also discussed the procedures to be followed for the BC census in the state with the CM.

BJP Membership Drive Likely to Fall Short of 25 Lakh Target in Telangana

TPN, Telangana: The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), which launched its membership drive in Telangana on September 8 with an ambitious target of enrolling 25 lakh members, is currently lagging behind, having enrolled only about 7 lakh members so far.

The first phase of the membership drive concluded on Wednesday, and with just two weeks remaining before the general membership drive ends, it may be challenging for the party to meet its goal. The active membership drive will continue from October 1 to 15, with a target of enrolling a minimum of 200 members from each polling booth across the state. Party leaders stated that those who enroll 100 members would likely be granted "active membership."

AIMIM May Expand into Rural Areas of Telangana zamabad, Sangareddy, Vikarabad,

TPN, Telangana: The All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM), led by Hyderabad MP Asaduddin Owaisi, is considering contesting elections in rural areas of Telangana for the first time. According to a report in the Times of India, the party is likely to participate in the upcoming panchayat elections in various districts.

Historically, AIMIM has not contested panchayat polls in Telangana but has previously supported candidates from other parties to prevent the division of Muslim votes. Sources indicate that the party may target constituencies in Karimnagar, Ni-

Adilabad, Nirmal, Khammam, and other areas.

In Telangana, AIMIM currently holds seven MLAs, two MLCs, and 44 corporators in the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC). The party also has representation in the legislative assemblies of other states, including one member in Bihar and two members in Maharashtra.

As the panchayat elections approach, it remains to be seen how effectively AIMIM can establish its presence in rural Telangana.



According to the party's claims, Telangana currently has about 14 lakh members, based on the last membership drive conducted three years ago. Nizamabad district leads in membership enrollment, with 3.50 lakh members.

The BJP has reportedly attracted 1.85 lakh new members through its website, the NaMo App, and other platforms, the highest in South India, with Karnataka coming second at 1.82 lakh.

Former MLC and State BJP membership committee convener N. Ramchandra Rao mentioned that the party conducted several workshops for its leaders and workers to train them on the membership drive. He expressed confidence that the party would achieve the target set by the leadership. "Due to the rain, our membership drive got delayed. We are doing well and will achieve our target," he said.

Meanwhile, it is reported that BJP national president and Union Minister JP Nadda will visit the state at the end of the month to motivate party activists to enroll more members.

Harish Rao Condemns Bank Officials' **Harassment of Farmers in Mancherial**

TPN, Telangana: Former Minister Harish Rao has expressed strong outrage over the mistreatment of a farmer by bank officials in Nennela Mandal, Mancherial District. He questioned the government's inaction, asking, "Is this the kind 🌇 of brutality and cruelty we are condoning?"

Rao criticized Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's promise of a ₹2 lakh loan waiver, labeling it a betrayal that has become a curse for farmers. He accused

the Chief Minister of neglect, pointing out that bank staff are harassing farmers by coming to their homes and demanding repayments.



Rains Turn Hyderabad Roads into Dangerous Obstacle Courses



TPN, Hyderabad: The recent rains have left Hyderabad's roads in a perilous state, transforming them into obstacle courses riddled with potholes, eroded tar, and gravel beds that pose serious risks to commuters. Main roads, such as the stretch from Banjara Hills Road No. 1 to the Masab Tank junction, have suffered significant damage. In front of Darussalam Bank, peeled-off tar has left behind gravel that causes vehicles to skid, leading to slow traffic and frequent jams, particularly during rush hours.

Hygiene Issues Found During Raids at Clubs in Hyderabad

TPN, Hyderabad: A task force team from the Food Safety Department of Telangana conducted raids at several popular clubs in Hyderabad, uncovering numerous irregularities. During the inspections, beetle infestations were discovered in wheat flour and urad dal stored in the storeroom. Additionally, dustbins were found open at various locations without proper lids. At Fateh Maidan Club, located in LB Stadium, Abids, the team noted that the windows were left open without insect-proof screens. They also found semi-prepared food items in the refrigerator that were uncovered and improperly labeled. Inspections at Supermarket and Sweet Shop Recently, raids were also carried out at a supermarket and a sweet shop in Hyderabad, specifically at Ratnadeep Retail Private Limited and Olive Mithai Shop. In recent months, similar inspections have targeted various popular restaurants, supermarkets, hostels, sweet shops, and PG accommodations in Hyderabad to ensure adherence to food quality standards. At Nizam Club, located in Saifabad, the team observed a live cockroach infestation inside the kitchen premises. They also reported water seepage from the ceiling above the grinding area, clogged drains, and stagnant water.



TPN, Telangana: Adilabad District police have successfully seized nearly 900 kilograms of ganja at the Lakshmipur check post in the Thalamadugu mandal of Adilabad district. District SP Ghaus Alam, IPS, revealed the details during a press conference held at the Thalamadugu police station. Navigating Complex Geopolitical Terrain Amid Violent Unrest



India and Myanmar share a unique 1,600-kilometer border, much of it unfenced, allowing for free movement of people under a 2017 Free Movement Agreement. However, recent violent unrest in Manipur, coupled with growing concerns over cross-border insurgency activities, has led to demands for the cancellation of this agreement and the construction of a secure border fence. Amid these tensions, India has initiated a new strategic approach to navigate the delicate situation in Myanmar, a country engulfed in fierce battles between the military junta and rebel coalitions.

The violence in Myanmar has intensified, with the military regime fighting against an increasingly unified rebel front. Rebel groups such as the National Unity Government (NUG), composed of factions like the Chin National Front, Arakan Army, and Kachin Independence Army, have gained substantial control the \$400 million Kaladan Multi-Modover the country. As they push for the overthrow of the military regime and the restoration of democracy, they have received support from Western nations. In contrast, the Myanmar military regime enjoys backing from China and Russia, creating a complicated geopolitical landscape for India.

Unpacking the US-Russia Election Interference Narrative

A Battle of Power and Propaganda



In recent years, accusations of election interference by Russia have become a recurring theme in US political discourse, with the 2024 presidential election shaping up to be no different. Earlier this month, the US administration once again raised alarms about Russia's alleged attempts to sway the upcoming election through disinformation campaigns and fake accounts spreading propaganda. US intelligence officials have labeled Russia as the "primary threat to elections," and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) continues its probe into Russia's activities, alongside smaller investigations into Iran's potential interference. However, while both countries are scrutinized, US officials maintain that Russia remains the more formidable actor, with a clear preference for Donald Trump.

Kejriwal Seeks Clarification from RSS Chief on BJP's Actions

AAP leader Arvind Kejriwal has written to RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat, expressing grave concerns about the trajectory of the BJP-led central government and its impact on Indian democracy. In his letter, Kejriwal stated, "If this continues, our country and democracy will be finished," reflecting his apprehensions about the current political climate.

During his "Janta Ki Adalat" rally, Kejriwal outlined five pressing questions directed at Bhagwat, seeking clarity on the BJP's political strategies. He questioned whether Bhagwat condones the party's alleged misuse of central agencies to undermine opposition parties and destabilize their governments. He also criticized the induction of "corrupt" leaders into the BJP, urging Bhagwat to clarify the party's stance on integrity in politics.

Additionally, Kejriwal raised concerns regarding the BJP's retirement age policy, specifically ask-



ing if it applies to Prime Minister Narendra Modi as it did for veteran leaders like L K Advani and Murli Manohar Joshi. He further inquired about Bhagwat's reaction to BJP chief J P Nadda's recent assertion that the party does not require the RSS, challenging the ideological foundations of the BJP.

Kejriwal emphasized that these questions resonate with many Indians, expressing hope that Bhagwat would consider them thoughtfully and provide answers. The letter underscores the growing tensions between the AAP and the BJP, as Kejriwal seeks to hold the ruling party accountable for its actions.

Delhi Chief Minister Atishi Announces New Minimum Wages

In her first press conference since assuming office, Delhi Chief Minister Atishi announced revised minimum wages for unorganised sector workers. The new rates are set at ₹18,066 for unskilled workers, ₹19,929 for semi-skilled workers, and ₹21,917 for skilled workers. This initiative reinforces the Aam Aadmi Party's (AAP) commitment to providing the highest minimum wages in the country.

Atishi used the platform to criticize the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), labeling it "anti-poor" and arguing that minimum wages in states governed by the BJP are often much lower than those in Delhi. She asserted that the Kejriwal government has not only established these wages through judicial support but has also ensured they are revised biannually, despite facing obstruction from the opposition.

The new wage structure is part of AAP's broader focus on labor rights and social welfare, emphasizing the importance of fair compensation for all workers. Atishi stated that the government's commitment to revising minimum wages reflects its dedication to supporting the working class and improving living standards.



Additionally, Atishi's announcement comes at a time when labor issues are increasingly at the forefront of political discussions. The AAP government aims to set a benchmark for workers' rights and compensation, positioning Delhi as a model for other states to follow.


Biden Will Be Most Proud Of Deepening Partnership With India: White House

As Biden prepares to exit the presidency, he has announced that he will not seek re-election, passing the mantle to Vice President Kamala Harris, who has made history as the first woman of Indian and Black heritage nominated for the presidency. In his farewell address at the UN General Assembly, Biden emphasized the importance of new leadership, stating, "Some things are more important than staying in power."

With presidential elections approaching on November 5, Biden's remarks signal a pivotal moment in both US politics and international relations, particularly concerning the enduring partnership with India.

Gunshots Fired at Kamala Harris' Arizona Campaign Office

Multiple gunshots were reported at the campaign office of U.S. Vice President Kamala Harris in Tempe, Arizona, early Monday morning. Police discovered damage from several bullets at the Democratic office located near Southern Avenue and Priest Drive. Fortunately, no one was inside at the time, but the incident has raised concerns about the safety of staff and nearby residents, according to Public Information Officer Ryan Cook.

The Tempe Police Department is currently investigating the incident as a potential property crime. Local news footage showed two bullet holes in a door and two more in the office windows. Investigators are analyzing the evidence collected from the scene, and additional security measures have been implemented for the safety of staff and surrounding individuals.

US Intel Warns Iran Threats To Assassinate Donald Trump

Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump received a briefing on Tuesday from U.S. intelligence officials regarding alleged threats from Iran to assassinate him. According to Trump's campaign, the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) indicated that these threats are "real and specific," aimed at destabilizing the United States. The campaign noted that intelligence assessments have shown an increase in Iranian threats in recent months, and U.S. government officials are taking steps to ensure Trump's safety while safeguarding the integrity of the upcoming elections.

Iran has consistently denied U.S. accusations of interfering in American affairs. The Iranian mission to the United Nations and the ODNI did not respond to requests for comment on the matter. Earlier this month, a Pakistani national with purported links to Iran pleaded not guilty to charges related to a plot to assassinate an American politician, identifying Trump as a potential target. However, sources stated that the accused did not intend for it to be a concrete plan against the former president.



Hezbollah fires missile at Mossad in response to Israeli strikes on Lebanon

Hezbollah launched a Qader 1 ballistic missile at Tel Aviv early Wednesday, escalating tensions following Israeli airstrikes in Lebanon that reportedly killed hundreds. The missile targeted the Israeli Mossad intelligence agency, which Hezbollah blames for recent assassinations of its leaders and a deadly attack involving hidden explosives. The Israeli military intercepted the missile, activating air raid sirens across central Israel, with no reported casualties or damage.

This incident marks the first time a missile from Lebanon reached central Israel. Hezbollah had previously claimed to target an intelligence base near Tel Aviv, but that attack was not confirmed. The ongoing conflict has seen an uptick in violence, with Hezbollah firing rockets into northern Israel in solidarity with Hamas, which is engaged in a separate conflict with Israel in Gaza.

Israeli airstrikes earlier this week have resulted in significant casualties, with reports indicating at least 560 people killed in Lebanon. This has prompted mass displacement, with families fleeing to cities like Beirut and Sidon, seeking refuge in schools and public spaces. The situation has led to a humanitarian crisis, with many attempting to leave Lebanon entirely.

Israel has conducted extensive airstrikes targeting Hezbollah's military capabilities, while warning of a potential wider military operation. The UN Security Council has scheduled an emergency meeting to address the situation in Lebanon at France's request.

The conflict, which has displaced tens of thousands, continues to escalate as both sides remain committed to their military objectives. Israel has moved troops from Gaza to its northern border in anticipation of further hostilities, and Hezbollah claims to have a substantial arsenal of rockets capable of striking anywhere in Israel. The cycle of violence shows no signs of abating, with both parties entrenched in their positions amid growing international concern.

Sri Lanka's President Has Called For A Snap

This incident marks the second reported act of vandalism at the office in just two weeks. Earlier, the front windows were damaged by what appeared to be BB gun or pellet gun fire on September 16. No arrests have been made in either case as authorities explore various angles and motives behind the attacks.

Sean McEnerney, the Arizona Democratic Party coordinated campaign manager, expressed gratitude to the Tempe Police for their swift response. "We are fortunate no one was present or injured," McEnerney said.

The shootings come just days before Vice President Harris is scheduled to visit Arizona, a crucial battleground state for the upcoming presidential election on November 5. During her trip, she plans to campaign across the state and visit the U.S.-Mexico border on Friday to address immigration concerns, a key issue where Republican candidate Donald Trump holds an advantage among voters. Federal authorities are currently investigating a possible assassination attempt on Trump at his golf course in Florida in mid-September, as well as a shooting incident during a rally in Pennsylvania in July. No evidence has emerged linking Iran to either of these incidents. Moreover, U.S. intelligence agencies reported last week that Iranian hackers sent emails containing stolen materials from Trump's campaign to individuals associated with the Democratic campaign of President Joe Biden, part of an alleged effort by Tehran to influence the U.S. electoral process. Following Biden's withdrawal from the race in late July, Democratic Vice President Kamala Harris emerged as the candidate facing Trump in the November 5 elections.

Canadian Prime Minister Trudeau Faces No-Confidence Vote In Parliament

On Tuesday, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's main rival, Conservative leader Pierre Poilievre, introduced a motion of no confidence against the ruling Liberal government, marking a significant challenge for Trudeau's minority administration. Following a debate in the House of Commons, a vote on the Conservative motion is set for Wednesday.

Poilievre, buoyed by strong public opinion polls, has been eager for a snap election since the leftist New Democratic Party (NDP) terminated its coalition agreement with the Liberals earlier this month, leaving Trudeau's government vulnerable. During the debate, Poilievre criticized Trudeau for failing to address rising living costs, the housing crisis, and increasing crime rates, while accusing him of doubling the national debt. He claimed that after nine years of Liberal rule, the prom-



ise of Canada is "broken" and vowed to implement a "common sense plan" to cut carbon taxes, build homes, manage the budget, and tackle crime if elected.

In response, Trudeau acknowledged the challenges Canadians are facing, stating, "People are hurting" and are struggling with basic expenses like groceries and rent. He vowed to continue fighting for the needs of Canadians, criticizing Poilievre's suggestion to cut essential services

and programs.

While the no-confidence motion is unlikely to succeed, as two smaller parties have indicated they will support the government, Poilievre has promised to persist, with another chance to challenge the government expected in early October. Trudeau first came to power in 2015 and has managed to maintain his position by defeating Poilievre's predecessors in elections in 2019 and 2021.

Recent polling shows the Conservatives leading with 43% support compared to the Liberals at 21% and the NDP at 19%. The current parliamentary landscape has the Liberals holding 153 seats, while the Conservatives have 119, the Bloc Quebecois has 33, and the NDP has 25. Analysts suggest that a general election may not occur until at least spring 2025.

General Election

Sri Lanka is set to hold a parliamentary election on November 14, following President Anura Kumara Dissanayake's decision to dissolve Parliament just weeks after his election. Here are five crucial reasons behind this move:

Dissanayake received 5.6 million votes (42.3%) in the recent presidential election, a significant increase from the 3% he garnered in 2019. This surge in support provides an opportunity for him to consolidate power in the 225-seat Parliament, capitalizing on the momentum of his recent victory.

As a candidate for the National People's Power alliance, which includes his Janatha Vimukhti Peremuna (JVP) party, Dissanayake's coalition currently holds only three seats in the existing parliament. Dissolving the legislature allows him to seek a stronger mandate and the necessary backing to fulfill his campaign promises, particularly those aimed at poverty alleviation and tax relief.

Sri Lanka is engaged in a four-year, \$2.9 billion bailout program with the International Monetary Fund (IMF), which has been essential for boosting foreign reserves and stabilizing the economy. However, the associated austerity measures have provoked public discontent. Dissanayake's campaign included promises to reduce taxes and amend the IMF deal, but he will require parliamentary support to implement these changes effectively.

The country is in the process of restructuring approximately \$25 billion in foreign debt. Gaining a supportive parliamentary majority will be critical for Dissanayake as he negotiates with bondholders. A unified legislative front may provide the assurance needed for creditors regarding the new government's policies.

Due to the limited number of seats held by his coalition, Dissanayake faced challenges in forming a comprehensive cabinet. He has only appointed a few ministers, retaining control of vital ministries such as finance and defense himself. A new election may enable him to appoint a fully-fledged cabinet that aligns with his governance agenda.

Overall, the snap election represents a strategic move by Dissanayake to solidify his leadership, address pressing economic issues, and implement his vision for Sri Lanka's recovery and growth.



In addition to the AI feature, YouTube is also expanding the rollout of "pause ads," which are advertisements that play when a video is paused. This initiative aims to create new revenue opportunities for creators while potentially enhancing viewer engagement.

Although the company did not provide details on when this conversational AI feature will be available outside the US, it represents a significant step in making video interactions more dynamic and informative for users. 




