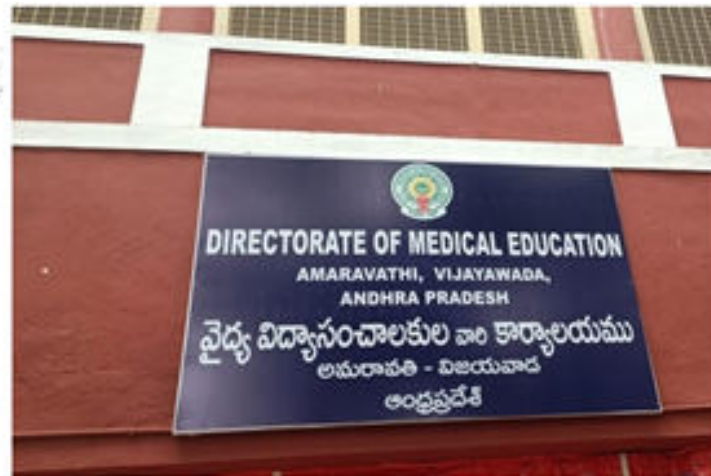
With these recent defections from the YCP, political analysts believe the Jana Sena is positioning itself to be a stronger contender in the state's political arena.

### KVR Distance Education

2 to 5 Lacs Collected From Each Candidates



**TPN ,V V S Madhu Babu:** A Scandal has erupted in the Director of Medical Education (DME) department, Vijayawada, where employees from Class 3 and Class 4 have allegedly secured promotions using fake certificates. The DME is accused of promoting 26 individuals as dietitians across Andhra Pradesh without verifying

the authenticity of their qualifications. These individuals, reportedly lacking basic knowledge about dietetics, have been elevated to positions that affect patients and healthcare professionals alike in government hospitals.

cent incident involves the supply of 1,110 kg of cashews and 700 kg of raisins, which were rejected by food safety authorities for violating FSSAI norms. It is alleged that the contractor is operating with the cooperation of certain officials within Durgagudi, which has raised concerns about the integrity of the procurement process. In light of these issues, there is a decision to investigate the quality of goods supplied to other temples in the state to ensure compliance with standards.

In the past, the same contractor was involved in supplying Low Grade Anna Prasada, notably providing Ding Dong brand rice instead of the Lalita brand, leading to significant backlash. The re-

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## The Red Book Already In Action.... Nara Lokesh

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"During my Yuvagalam padayatra, devotees raised issues about the poor quality of the Tirumala laddu. Once in power, we addressed these concerns and asked the EO to clean up the TTD," Lokesh said. He also questioned why YV Subbareddy reduced the rule on the turnover of ghee suppliers from Rs. 250 crores to Rs. 150 crores, stating that a committee has been formed to investigate the irregularities.

Taking further jabs, Lokesh said, "We are not like Jagan, who runs away. We have already implemented pensions and fulfilled our Mega DSC guarantees. We will provide free gas cylinders from Diwali as promised." He also criticized the YCP-backed \*Sakshi\* news outlet, calling it "harmful to health," and reaffirmed that there will be no privatization of Visakha Steel. Lokesh concluded by accusing Jagan of using public funds for personal protection while failing to help people during recent floods.

## Promotion With Fake Certificates... KVR Distance Education

The employees, who allegedly paid between Rs. 2 to 5 lakhs per post, are said to have obtained fraudulent certificates claiming they completed dietitian courses through distance education in neighboring states. Many of these certificates were obtained from private institutions like the KVR Distinction Education Center, which has been accused of running a certificate-selling racket.

Former Chief Dietitian M. Ramakrishna Prasad, who passed away two years ago, had raised concerns about the authenticity of these certificates. He had filed a complaint with the DME, highlighting that the certificates used by these 26 employees were fake. Ramakrishna Prasad's allegations resurfaced after his death, drawing attention to the ongoing malpractice.

It has been reported that 18 of these certificates bear identical serial numbers, raising further suspicions. When sent to the issuing university in Tamil Nadu for verification, the institution allegedly responded that the certificates were genuine, prompting doubts about the university's involvement or oversight. The scandal came to light following a complaint from GGH Vijayawada lab technician, K. Somaiah, who highlighted the irregular promotion of a junior assistant, G. Jaganmohan Rao, to assistant librarian at Government Siddhartha Vaidya College, despite government regulations. This sparked an internal investigation, which exposed the widespread use of fake certificates in the DME department.

Somaiah's complaint led to calls for Jaganmohan Rao's immediate demotion, claiming that he had passed exams through illegal means. Similarly, another junior assistant, Balakrishna, from the Government Dental College, Vijayawada, was also controversially promoted to assistant librarian.

Additionally, allegations have been made against a top official in the DME, previously accused of corruption, for driving these fraudulent promotions. Reports suggest that this official is connected to a controversial spouse case involving a sanitation inspector who also worked as a dietitian in a government hospital.

There are growing demands for Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister to order a thorough investigation into the promotions of these dietitians. Medical education groups are urging that deserving candidates receive the positions instead of those using fake certificates. The promotion scandal has shed light on the thriving black market for certificates in places like Vijayawada, Nandigama, and Guntur. Distance education centers have allegedly been issuing certificates in exchange for money, enabling individuals to bypass proper educational channels and secure higher positions fraudulently.

The Commissioner of the Endowments Department has stated that any supplier found delivering sub-standard products will be blacklisted. The commissioner's warning has prompted officials to prepare for strict action against those compromising the quality of offerings in temples.

Officials are now planning to act on the Commissioner's directives to ensure that such incidents are not repeated and that the quality of goods supplied to temples is maintained at the highest standards. This swift action is seen as necessary to uphold the sanctity of temple offerings and protect the interests of devotees.

## New Liquor Shops Guidelines Finalized in AP



**TPN, Andhra Pradesh:** The Excise Department of Andhra Pradesh is preparing to release a notification for the establishment of new liquor shops across the state. A total of 3,736 liquor shops will be allocated, with 340 shops specifically designated for stone carving professionals. The department is currently assessing how to allocate these shops within the reservation quota, based on the population of Kallugeeta occupational castes.

As part of the new liquor policy, the government aims to implement a private retail system for liquor sales, with the duration of the new licenses set at two years. This initiative is expected to encourage increased participation from retailers. Officials have been instructed to ensure that a variety of high-quality products are made available at competitive prices. Following a review of liquor prices in neighboring states, it has been determined that the price of a quart should be set at Rs. 99 in Andhra Pradesh.

Additionally, the government plans to phase out newly introduced brands from the previous administration, replacing them with well-known and established brands. To cater to premium customers, 12 elite shops will be permitted to open statewide, focusing exclusively on premium liquor brands alongside general liquor stores. Licensees will also have the option to establish walk-in stores adjacent to their shops, for which an additional fee of Rs. 5 lakh will be required.

Furthermore, microbreweries that produce and sell draft beer will be allowed to operate again. These microbreweries can brew and sell beer periodically, and the final arrangements are being made to ensure that those opening microbreweries pay the same licensing fee as bars. The Excise Department is finalizing these guidelines to facilitate the growth of the liquor retail sector in the state.

## One Teacher per Class Policy to Be Implemented Next Year: Minister Nara Lokesh

**TPN, Andhra Pradesh:** State Education, IT, and Electronics Minister Nara Lokesh announced that government schools in Andhra Pradesh will adopt a one teacher per class policy starting next year. This declaration followed a surprise inspection at the Municipal Corporation Elementary School in Etcherla Veedhi, Sriakulam, where the minister engaged with students from classes 1 to 5. During the visit, Lokesh interacted with the students, inquiring about their favorite subjects, which were revealed to be English and Environmental Studies (EVS). He also asked about their lunch, their parents' occupations, and the quality of their uniforms and bags. The minister praised the students' handwriting after reviewing their workbooks and commended their efforts to improve their skills.

Recognizing the students' interest in local cuisine for their mid-day meals, Lokesh advised the authorities to consider incorporating local foods into the menu.

### Embracing the Role of a Teacher

In a playful twist, Minister Lokesh took on the role of a teacher during the inspection, conducting an IQ test with the students, who responded in Telugu. He shared moments of



joy with the children, joking with them about classroom antics. When asked what they desired for their classroom, the students requested benches, which the minister assured would be arranged.

After the classroom visits, Lokesh held a meeting with teachers, the Mandal Education Officer (MEO), and school staff to emphasize the importance of government school inspections. He expressed surprise upon learning that the school had been constructed a century ago and noted the dilapidated state of some classrooms, where teachers had spent personal

funds on repairs.

### Commitment to Infrastructure Improvement

Minister Lokesh committed to providing basic infrastructure for government schools before proceeding with further developments. He acknowledged the good attendance and results at the school while addressing concerns regarding salary delays for staff. He instructed the MEO to ensure timely payment. The minister called for collective efforts from all stakeholders, including collectors and teachers, to enhance educational standards in government schools. He outlined his vision for making Andhra Pradesh schools exemplary within the next five years and emphasized the need for planned reforms to rectify past mistakes.

Teachers' suggestions were welcomed, particularly regarding the shortage of subject-specific teaching assistants, which Lokesh pledged to address more vigorously in the upcoming year.

Lokesh was accompanied by MLA Gondu Shankar and MLC Vepada Chiranjeevi during his visit.

## Jagan Christian, Declaration Required for Tirumala Visit, Says RRR



**TPN, Andhra Pradesh:** TDP MLA Raghuramakrishna Raju has made pointed remarks regarding YCP chief Jagan's upcoming visit to Tirumala Srivari on the 28th of this month, stating that he must sign a declaration affirming his faith in Hinduism. Raju highlighted that Jagan is known to be a Christian and emphasized that visitors of different faiths should adhere to the rules when visiting the sacred site. Raju stated, "Anyone who goes to Tirumala should follow the rules, and Jagan must declare his faith in Hinduism and Swami before his visit." He further added that if Jagan wishes to

partake in the revered Tirumala Laddu, he should do so with genuine faith and not just out of formality.

Expressing his sentiments, Raju conveyed his belief that the Venkateswara Swamy has invited Jagan to Tirumala to seek atonement. He recalled that when Chandrababu Naidu was Chief Minister, he honored the sanctity of Swami's laddu, which was known for its purity. Raju concluded by asserting that programs across temples in the state will be conducted in accordance with Hindu sentiments, ensuring there is no misconduct involved.

## Kukkala Vidyasagar Challenges Remand in Jithwani Case in AP HC

**TPN, Vijayawada:** Kukkala Vidyasagar, designated as A1 in the ongoing case involving Mumbai film actress Jithwani, has filed a petition in the Andhra Pradesh High Court challenging his remand.

During the hearing, the police informed the court that they would not exert pressure regarding the investigation related to Vidyasagar's petition to retrieve dogs currently in custody. In response, the High Court directed the authorities to submit a detailed counter regarding the specifics of Vidy-



asagar's remand. The court has adjourned further proceedings in the case until October 1, 2024. Legal representatives from both sides

are expected to present their arguments at the next hearing.

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## Minister Atchannaaidu Counter Back To Vijay Sai Reddy...

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The war of words between YCP Rajya Sabha member Vijayasai Reddy and TDP leader and Minister Atchannaaidu continues to escalate. It all started when Vijayasai Reddy expressed anger at the suggestion that he attempted to join the Kamma community party, TDP Atchannaaidu, in response, did not hold back and delivered a sharp counter to Vijayasai's remarks, with both sides exchanging personal insults. Atchannaaidu retorted, saying, "Vijayasai Reddy, neither we nor our party have the corrupt mindset to exploit money or the wickedness to advise on financial crimes like you. You are a wretched man who harbors even five demons. The way you speak about others shows that you have a serious mental problem. It's time for karma to catch up with you... Prepare yourself for a long prison sentence."



Atchannaaidu emphasized that his party was given the wisdom to serve the people. He accused Vijayasai of realizing that sins must be punished and that he had made a desperate attempt to switch from YCP to TDP. "People like you, criminals and financial maniacs, have no place in the TDP," he added. Atchannaaidu further clarified, "No matter how many pretenses you and your leader Jagan put on, your sins have come to fruition, and you will be punished for every mistake you have made."

## Control Your Loud Mouth – Kollu Ravindra

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: AP Minister Kollu Ravindra has launched a scathing attack on YCP leader and former minister Perni Nani over comments related to the Tirumala Laddu controversy. Ravindra accused Nani of hypocrisy, stating that despite having served as the Minister of Transport, he failed to develop the Bandaru Bus Stand and is now making a fuss over the Laddu issue. "If you don't control your mouth, your teeth will fall out," he warned. Ravindra further criticized Nani for supporting YCP leader Jagan, saying, "Your leader Jagan has no faith in Kali Yuga God Venkateswara Swamy. Aren't you ashamed to back such a person? If you truly believe in Venkateswara Swami, do you even offer silk clothes to Swami at least once every five years?" He also questioned Nani's integrity, asking, "Were



you not ashamed even when the crowd beat you up in the temple the other day?" He expressed that the people of the port would chase Nani away if he continued to behave inappropriately. Ravindra emphasized that if Nani speaks out again, he will be told to "shut his mouth." In response to the allegations regarding the Tirumala Laddu, Nani stated, "They are spreading malicious propaganda that animal fat has been mixed in Tirumala Laddu. Swami Prasad is being used for political gains. Chandrababu and Lokesh are spreading these evil words, and Pawan Kalyan is echoing them. The alliance leaders have defiled the sanctity of Tirumala. We will perform a puja on the 28th of this month to seek forgiveness for the sins of the alliance leaders."

## We Will End All The Anarchy Caused by Kodali Nani

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a press conference held at the TDP central office, Mangalagiri, Gudivada MLA Venigandla Ramu condemned comments made by YCP leader Kodali Nani regarding the sanctity of the Laddu Prasadam in Tirumala. Ramu was joined by APSRTC Chairman Konakalla Narayana Rao and Palmeru MLA Varla Kumar Raja. Ramu criticized Kodali Nani for his "taunting" remarks about the idols that devotees worship with great reverence, stating, "Those who cannot help when people are in trouble, especially during floods, should not speak without thinking and hurt the sentiments of crores of people." He further challenged Nani, asserting, "If you have the guts, come to Gudivada



and face the people. They will spit on your face." Ramu emphasized that just mentioning Kodali Nani's name

ignites anger among the public. He vowed to eradicate the corruption and land grabs that occurred under Nani's watch, stating, "We will remove all the anarchy caused by Kodali Nani." Ramu also criticized Chief Minister Jagan for being unable to handle the popularity of his predecessor, Chandrababu Naidu. "The people have trampled Jagan and his party to the depths for the sins and misdeeds committed," he said, emphasizing that even after a significant electoral defeat, Nani continues to behave irrationally. He denounced Nani's claims of being a "brand ambassador of Hinduism," asserting that comments about inferior ghee being used in the sacred temple have hurt the sentiments of millions of devotees worldwide. "Due to their stupidity, they have offended the feelings of crores of devotees who worship at Tirumala," Ramu concluded.

## "When Did I Try to Join TDP?": Vijayasai Reddy

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: YCP Rajya Sabha member Vijayasai Reddy hit back at TDP leader and minister Atchannaaidu with sharp comments, following claims made by Atchannaaidu that Vijayasai had attempted to join the TDP. In response to these remarks, Vijayasai Reddy took to social media platform X (formerly Twitter) and launched a scathing attack. "Atchannaaidu! When God created you, He gave you only 0.1% of brain, intelligence, and knowledge! When you were young, your friends probably played games like 'Achchi... Buchi... Katchi...!' Your actions and words are strange because your brain hasn't grown in proportion to your body," Vijayasai Reddy remarked. He further dismissed the allegation, questioning, "Did I, Vijayasai Reddy, try to join TDP? Atchannaaidu... No matter how much you wish for it, this dream of yours will never come true in this lifetime! If you want to dive into the



world of illusions, go ahead, no one can stop you." He concluded his tweet with a stinging remark, "You seem to think you have the strength of a pair of bulls. The problem with you is that you don't understand the difference between 'Matho Shakti' and horizontal-vertical." This sharp retort from Vijayasai Reddy has added fuel to the ongoing political sparring between the YCP and TDP leaders.

## Purandeshwari's Sensational Demand for Jagan On His Tirumala Visit

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The controversy surrounding the Tirumala Srivari Laddu took a sensational turn as AP CM Jagan Mohan Reddy faces criticism over allegations made by Chandrababu Naidu regarding the adulteration of the iconic laddu with animal fat and fish oil. The NDA alliance parties in Andhra Pradesh are intensifying their scrutiny of the YCP government over this matter. In a recent statement, Jagan announced his intention to visit Tirumala, claiming to be a devotee of Lord Venkateswara. This declaration has sparked new discussions across the state, especially concerning the customs and practices associated with visiting the temple. Responding to Jagan's announcement, BJP state president Daggubati Purandeshwari stated that anyone visiting Tirumala, including Jagan, must submit a declaration of faith. Purandeshwari emphasized the long-standing tradition of requiring such declarations for non-Hindus, urging Jagan to comply before his visit to the temple. In her post on the social media platform X, Purandeshwari noted that Jagan is expected to visit Tirumala on the 28th of this month. She cited existing regulations that mandate non-Hindus to make a declaration at the Vaikuntam Q Complex prior to performing darshan, according to Rule 136 of TTD General Rules.



Purandeshwari referenced a government order (G.O. Rule No. 16) that requires a declaration at the Garuda idol at Alipiri for those seeking to demonstrate their faith. She called for Jagan to fill out the declaration form before stepping foot in Tirumala, reminding followers that this process is essential for maintaining the sanctity of the temple. As the BJP and various Hindu groups continue to target Jagan over this declaration issue, it remains to be seen whether he will comply and visit the Lord at Tirumala as planned.

## YS Sharmila Comments on Political Journey and CM's Post

We Will reach the peak Of AP Politics: YS Sharmila

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: PCC Chief YS Sharmila made significant remarks during the meeting of the APCC working group held in Vijayawada. She discussed her political journey, the decisions taken so far, their implementation, and the Congress party's goals in the state, emphasizing the efforts to make Rahul Gandhi the Prime Minister. She directed the cadre to work accordingly. Sharmila expressed that she never thought she would enter politics, but circumstances led her to this point. She recalled that in the past, her father had merged the Reddy Congress with the YSR Congress Party, subsequently becoming the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh. Now, she has merged the YSR Telangana Party into Congress. While she acknowledged that she could have taken a Rajya Sabha seat or any other position during the merger, she stated that she does not need that in Telangana. She emphasized that their struggle in Telangana is crucial for bringing Congress to power and asserted that the party must also regain power in Andhra Pradesh.



She explained that her focus is here, which is why she has taken on the responsibilities assigned by the party. Reminding everyone of YSR's wish for Rahul Gandhi to become Prime Minister, Sharmila stated that she has no desire to become Chief Minister. She stressed that the goal is to ensure that Rahul becomes Prime Minister, as only then will they secure special status and fulfill all the promises made during partition. Sharmila reminded the leaders that the Congress party is currently at the bottom in the state, with a significant challenge ahead. She encouraged them by saying that if

they take each step, the hill will not seem so daunting. "Not only can we overcome this hill, but we can also reach the peak," she asserted. She urged every leader of the Congress party to work diligently, believing that many miracles could happen in the next five years. Sharmila identified two main objectives: strengthening the party and standing up politically. She emphasized that the survival of the Congress party is essential for the state. She also noted that they are the opposition in the state while Babu, Jagan, and Pawan are making the BJP their master.





## The Karnataka Conundrum: Siddaramaiah Faces Legal Setback Amid Political Tensions



Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah faces a critical challenge as the Karnataka High Court recently rejected his petition challenging Governor Thaaawarchand Gehlot's sanction to prosecute him in a land scam. This legal setback has opened the door to an investigation into allegations of unlawful allotment of housing plots by the Mysore Urban Development Authority (MUDA) to Siddaramaiah's wife, Parvathi, a case that could disrupt his political future and destabilize his government.

Siddaramaiah was counting on a favorable verdict, but the court's rejection of his petition has sparked political turmoil. The case, now widely referred to as the "MUDA muddle," centers on the alleged improper allotment of 14 housing plots in Mysuru, with reports suggesting the scandal benefited Siddaramaiah's family by approximately ₹56 crore. The court decision allows anti-corruption agencies to investigate under the Prevention of Corruption Act, marking a significant escalation in the case.

Justice M. Nagaprasanna's ruling noted that it was difficult to dismiss Siddaramaiah's involvement in the land deal, indicating that an investigation was necessary. The judgment upheld the Governor's approval of the probe, allowing Right to Information (RTI) activists, who had brought the allegations to light, to pursue the case further. This has emboldened the opposition, with the BJP and Janata Dal (Secular) (JD(S)) calling for Siddaramaiah's resignation.

Siddaramaiah, however, has dismissed the calls to step down, vowing to fight the case in court and claiming that the allegations are part of a larger political conspiracy orchestrated by his rivals in the BJP and JD(S). He remains firm in his stance, asserting that he will eventu-

ally be vindicated. However, the uncertainty surrounding his future has left his administration on shaky ground.

### Congress's Dilemma

For the ruling Congress, the situation presents a significant dilemma. Forcing Siddaramaiah to resign would fuel opposition attacks and possibly destabilize the government. However, allowing him to remain in power could undermine the party's moral standing and lead to further political instability, especially with Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar waiting in the wings.

Shivakumar, Siddaramaiah's long-time rival within the party, has not hidden his ambition to occupy the top post. While Shivakumar has publicly expressed support for Siddaramaiah, calling the allegations a BJP conspiracy, there are concerns that the internal power struggle could escalate if the legal issues surrounding Siddaramaiah worsen.

At the heart of Congress's challenge is the potential alienation of Siddaramaiah's strong support base, known as AHINDA, which stands for minorities, backward classes, and Dalits. These groups have traditionally been loyal to Siddaramaiah, and any forced leadership change could fracture the party's voter base ahead of future elections.

The party's high command faces a delicate balancing act. Despite the legal troubles, Siddaramaiah still enjoys considerable support from Congress MLAs. While Shivakumar's influence cannot be overlooked, any attempt to replace Siddaramaiah now may lead to internal dissent and a leadership crisis.

### Opposition Gains Momentum

Meanwhile, the opposition, especially the BJP, has seized

the opportunity to pressure Siddaramaiah and the Congress government. BJP state president BY Vijayendra, alongside opposition leader R Ashok, has demanded Siddaramaiah's resignation, citing the court's ruling as confirmation of corruption. The BJP has called for a Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) probe to ensure an impartial investigation.

JD(S), another opposition party, has also capitalized on the controversy, using the court decision to label Siddaramaiah as corrupt. Social media campaigns have targeted the Chief Minister, with JD(S) dubbing him "Whitener Ramaiah" in reference to the alleged "black spots" of corruption in his political career.

With by-elections looming in three key constituencies—Channapatna, Shiggaon, and Sandur—the opposition is eager to exploit Siddaramaiah's legal troubles. The by-elections, scheduled following the election of three sitting MLAs to parliament, are seen as a litmus test for the Congress government's stability and voter sentiment.

Political analysts warn that while Siddaramaiah remains in office for now, the Congress party will have to tread carefully. "Siddaramaiah will continue as Chief Minister for the time being, but the party must brace itself for potential disturbances," notes political analyst Harish Ramaswamy. The legal battle ahead is likely to impact governance, with social welfare schemes and policy implementation potentially taking a backseat.

The road ahead for Siddaramaiah remains uncertain, as his political future hinges on navigating both legal and intra-party challenges. The Congress, too, faces an uphill battle to maintain its grip on power amid growing opposition pressure and internal fissures.

## Are We Already In An AI Bubble?

The question of whether we are in an AI bubble is on many people's minds, and the answer seems elusive. With the global buzz around artificial intelligence, the extraordinary amount of money flowing into the industry, and concerns about whether these investments will pay off, it's a timely topic to explore. This issue also carries significant implications for India, which is rapidly emerging as a key player in the AI space.

### The Global Picture: Cooling Hype?

Recent data suggest that the investor frenzy around AI might be slowing down. According to *The Economist*, some of the largest AI companies have seen their stock prices drop by as much as 15% in recent months. What's more startling is that only about 4.8% of American companies are currently using AI in their products or services, down from earlier this year. This statistic is surprising given all the hype around AI's transformative potential.

A recent Goldman Sachs report titled *Gen AI: Too Much Spend, Too Little Benefit?* echoes these concerns. Jim Covello, Head of Global Equity Research, argues that while over \$1 trillion is expected to be spent on AI infrastructure and development in the coming years, there is growing skepticism about whether these investments will deliver returns. AI has not yet proved to be a technology that reduces costs in the way previous tech shifts, like cloud computing or automation, did. Instead, developing and running AI systems, especially the large, sophisticated models like OpenAI's GPT-4, is extraordinarily expensive.

### The High Cost of AI

Training advanced AI models like GPT-4 requires immense computational power, with estimates suggesting that it consumes enough energy to power 50 American homes for a century. Current costs for training such models can reach as high as \$100 million, and future generations could cost \$1

billion or more. In addition to training, the operational costs for answering queries or completing complex tasks also rack up, with some reports estimating that summarising financial reports could cost upwards of \$223,000. These high costs are raising eyebrows among investors, even though a staggering \$95 billion has already been invested into AI startups this year alone.

### Entrepreneurial Optimism: Betting Big on AI

Despite these concerns, the entrepreneurial spirit around AI remains undeterred. Mukesh Bansal, a seasoned entrepreneur, recently launched Nurix.ai and secured \$27 million in funding, demonstrating the continued belief in AI's potential. This optimism is not isolated; there is a palpable sense that a new wave of AI startups, particularly from India, is poised to make a global impact.

India has already witnessed a boom in Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) companies going global, and AI could be the next frontier. Indian AI startups are not just chasing the hype but are focused on solving real-world problems in industries like healthcare, education, and agriculture. With the proliferation of generative AI tools, powerful capabilities are being placed in the hands of everyday users, democratising access to technologies that were previously reserved for experts or large corporations.

### Are We in an AI Bubble?

The juxtaposition of massive spending and skepticism from some quarters with the relentless optimism of entrepreneurs creates a complex landscape. On one hand, there is genuine concern that we are in an AI bubble. The high costs, coupled with unclear immediate benefits, have led many to wonder whether AI can live up to its transformative promise.

On the other hand, it is clear that AI has already made significant advancements, and dis-

missing its long-term potential could be short-sighted. Even if some investors may be overestimating the speed at which AI can revolutionize industries, the technology's potential to transform sectors like healthcare, logistics, and customer service is undeniable.

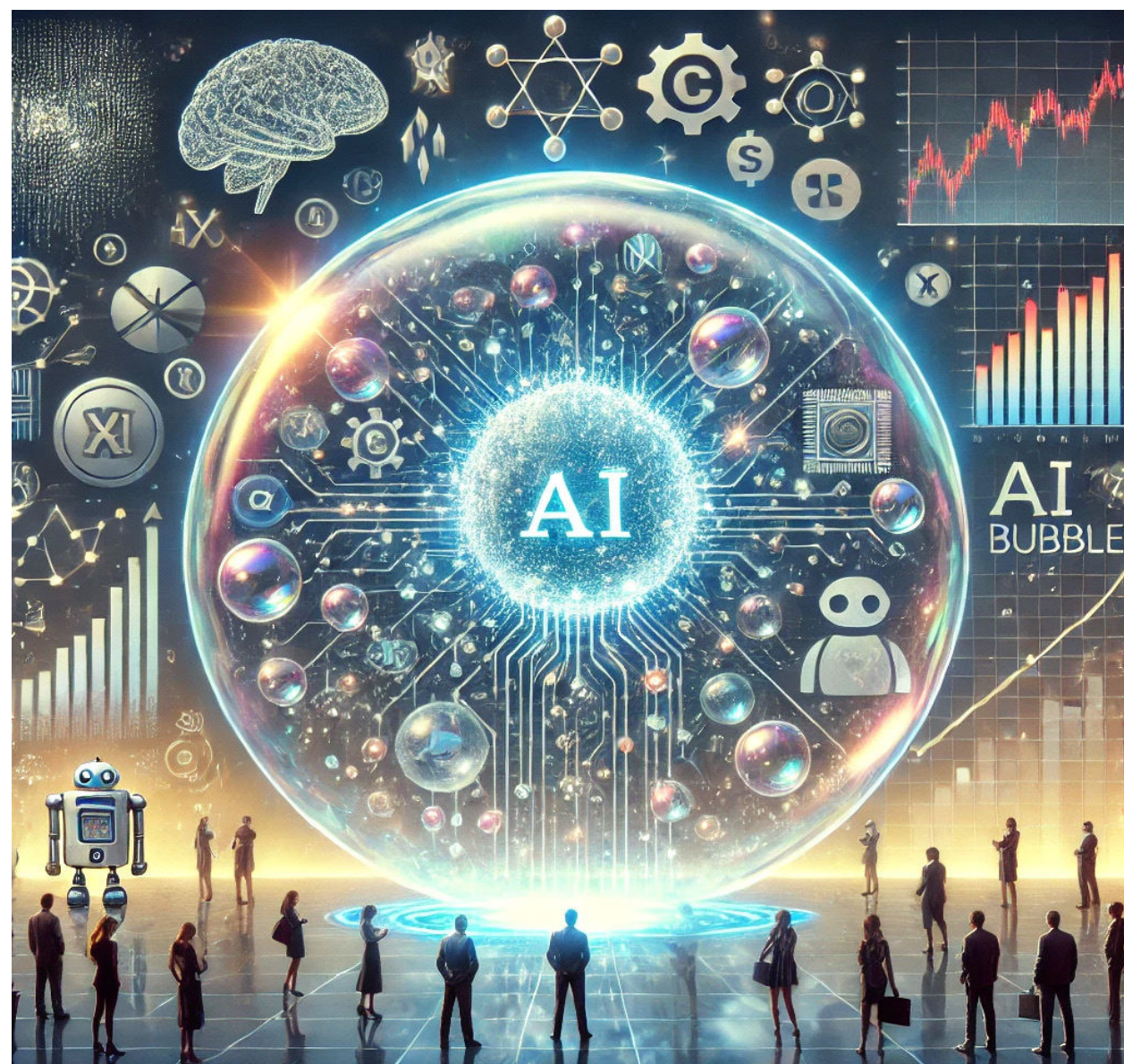
The truth may lie somewhere in the middle. While there may be elements of overexuberance, AI is still in its early stages, and its full potential has yet to be realized. Much like the dot-com bubble of the late 1990s, which birthed the internet giants that dominate today's economy, the AI "bubble" could eventually produce breakthroughs that redefine industries.

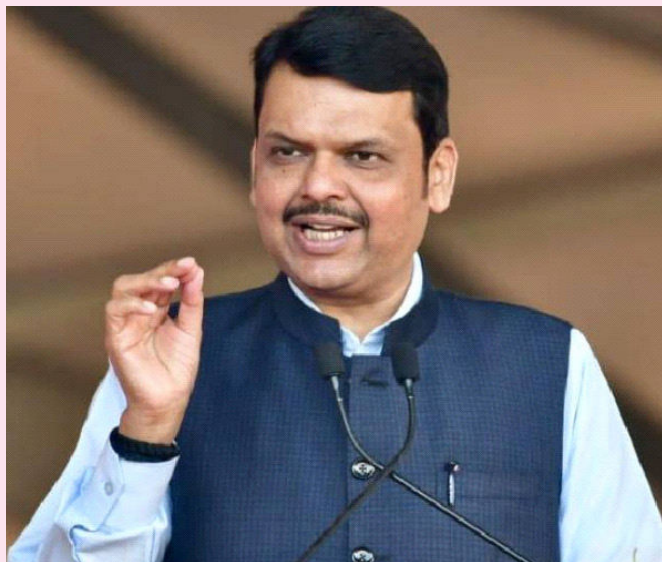
### What Does This Mean for India?

## BJP's Core Voter Base Did Not Like Alliance With NCP": Devendra Fadnavis

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis acknowledged on Thursday that the BJP's alliance with the Ajit Pawar-led Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) was initially unpopular with the party's core voter base. Speaking at the India Today Conclave, Fadnavis attributed the BJP's disappointing performance in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls in Maharashtra to poor vote transfers from the NCP.

The BJP-led alliance, which includes Eknath Shinde's Shiv Sena, managed to win just 17 of the 48 Lok Sabha seats in the state, with the BJP securing only nine, down from 23 in the 2019 polls. Fadnavis admitted that the BJP's "core voter base" was uncomfortable with the alliance, but added that "80 per cent" of the voters have now accepted the necessity of such "political compromises."

"It is true this is the BJP's worst performance in recent general elections. We contested 28 seats but won very few. However, we lost 12 seats by a margin of just 3,000 to 6,000 votes, and we still received the highest number of votes overall," Fadnavis said.

He explained that the BJP's long-standing alliance with Shiv Sena made vote transfers easier, but the NCP, being a former rival, faced challenges in transferring its votes to the BJP. Fadnavis expressed confidence that these issues would not affect the upcoming Maharashtra Assembly polls.

The senior BJP leader also admitted that the alliance was a difficult decision for the party's base, but necessary for political reasons. "There are compromises that go against what you truly believe, but you still move forward. I can guarantee that at least 80 per cent of our voter base is now convinced of the need to ally with NCP," he said. Fadnavis further stated that discussions over 80 per cent of the state's 288 assembly seats are complete and that "winnability" would be the primary focus in the upcoming elections, likely to be held in November.

## CBI Biased: Karnataka Withdraws Agency's Permission to Investigate Cases in State

Karnataka on Friday officially withdrew open consent for the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to conduct inquiries within its jurisdiction, citing concerns over the agency's alleged bias. Law Minister HK Patil explained that the decision was driven by the state's dissatisfaction with the CBI's handling of investigations, ruling out any direct connection to the ongoing MUDA land scam involving Chief Minister Siddaramaiah.

"We are withdrawing open consent for the CBI investigation in the state due to concerns about their biased actions," Patil said during a press briefing, adding that the move aimed to "control the CBI from taking the wrong path." He emphasized that the state's cabinet stood in solidarity with Siddaramaiah, encouraging him to fight back against allegations.

The decision places Karnataka among a growing list of opposition-ruled states, including West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, and Kerala, which have also revoked open consent for the CBI. Without this consent, the CBI now requires specific approval from the state government for each investigation.

This move comes amid heightened tensions between opposition states and the BJP-led central government, with many opposition leaders accusing the BJP of using the CBI to target political opponents ahead of elections. Patil noted that in several cases referred to the CBI by the Karnataka government, the agency failed to file chargesheets or refused to investigate.

# PM Launches 3 Supercomputers, Says Science For Self-Reliance Our Mission

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday launched three indigenously developed PARAM Rudra supercomputers under the National Supercomputing Mission, emphasizing India's commitment to leveraging science and technology for self-reliance. Speaking via video link, PM Modi said that India's vision for progress is driven by technological advancements, and these supercomputers mark a significant step in creating new opportunities in various fields.

Lauding the progress since the launch of the National Supercomputing Mission in 2015, PM Modi highlighted that India's leadership in quantum computing technology is poised to boost industries such as IT, manufacturing, MSMEs, and startups. He underlined the government's focus on making scientific research accessible to benefit the common man.

"Science for self-reliance is our mission," the Prime Minister stated, adding that research, technology, and computing power should serve to empower the poor and ensure inclusive



development.

The three PARAM Rudra supercomputers, built at a cost of ₹130 crore, are deployed in Pune, Delhi, and Kolkata to support cutting-edge research in scientific fields. PM Modi also inaugurated an ₹850 crore High-Performance Computing (HPC) sys-

tem dedicated to weather and climate research, calling it a "very big achievement" for India's technological progress.

"Technology is integral to every sector, and our share in the technological revolution must be in terabytes and petabytes, not just bits and bytes," he said,

reflecting on India's growing role in global computing.

The supercomputers will support research across various domains. Pune's Giant Metre Radio Telescope (GMRT) will explore astronomical phenomena like Fast Radio Bursts (FRBs), while the Inter University Accelerator Centre (IUAC) in Delhi will advance material science and atomic physics. In Kolkata, the S N Bose Centre will drive research in cosmology, physics, and earth sciences.

The HPC systems, named 'Arka' and 'Arunika,' are specially designed for meteorological applications, improving the accuracy of predictions for extreme weather events such as cyclones, heatwaves, and heavy rainfall.

PM Modi also reaffirmed India's efforts to build a domestic semiconductor ecosystem, ensuring the nation plays a crucial role in the global supply chain. He further noted that preparations for India's Mission Gaganyaan, which aims to establish a space station by 2035, are underway.

## False Records Created In Police Station": Agency's Big Claim In RG Kar Case



In a major development in the RG Kar Hospital rape-murder case, the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has revealed that false records related to the case were created at the Tala Police Station in Kolkata. This revelation comes as part of the agency's investigation into the killing of a 31-year-old junior doctor last month. The CBI also stated that it had obtained CCTV footage from the police station, which has been sent to a central forensics lab for examination.

Abhijit Mondal, the officer-in-charge of Tala Police Station at the time, has been arrested on charges of tampering with evidence. He is currently in judicial custody, along with Dr. Sandip Ghosh, the hospital's former chief, who has been arrested over financial irregularities. The prime suspect in the case, Sanjay Roy, a civic volunteer, was also arrested after being seen on CCTV footage entering the room where the doctor's body was found.

The CBI is investigating a possible conspiracy between Mondal, Ghosh, and Roy, highlighting a suspicious delay in seizing key evidence. Additionally, both the High Court and Supreme Court have raised concerns over the 14-hour delay between the discovery of the body and the filing of a police case.

## Hemant Soren "Pretending To Be Martyr" After Going To Jail: Rajnath Singh

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Thursday launched a scathing attack on Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren, accusing him of "pretending to be a martyr" following his imprisonment on corruption charges. Speaking at a Parivartan rally, Singh urged the public to remove the JMM-led government from power, arguing that a leader involved in corruption cannot guide Jharkhand toward development.

"Hemant Soren is pretending to be a 'martyr' after going to jail on corruption charges. Such corrupt CM cannot lead Jharkhand towards development. Show the exit door to such forces and give two consecutive terms to BJP for unparalleled development of the state," Singh declared.

Singh also accused the current administration of encouraging "infiltration and conversion" for political benefits, contrasting this with the BJP's promise to provide housing for all within three years if voted back into power.

The Defence Minister further advocated for the "one nation, one election" policy, stating that it could save the exchequer ₹4 lakh crore, as frequent elections currently cost around ₹7 lakh crore. Singh also took aim at Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, accusing him of tarnishing India's image abroad and asserting that India is no longer a weak nation. He warned that any provocation against India would have consequences, referencing the country's actions against Pakistan as an example.



## Salute Their Bravery": President Droupadi Murmu Visits Siachen Base Camp

On Thursday, President Droupadi Murmu visited the Siachen base camp, addressing soldiers stationed at the world's highest battlefield. She praised their bravery and resilience in the face of extreme conditions, acknowledging the sacrifices they make to protect the nation. As the supreme commander of the armed forces, President Murmu said she felt immense pride, declaring, "All citizens salute their bravery."

The President highlighted the challenges soldiers face, such as heavy snowfall and temperatures dropping to minus 50 degrees, yet they remain steadfast in their duty. She emphasized that all Indians recognize and respect their sacrifice and commitment.

During her visit, President Murmu, dressed in military attire, paid tribute to the fallen soldiers at the Siachen War Memorial. She remarked that the memorial stands as a testament to the courage of those martyred since the launch of Operation Meghdoot in 1984, under which India gained control over the Siachen Glacier.

The President's visit to Siachen marks her as the third Indian president to visit the base camp, following A P J Abdul Kalam in 2004 and Ram Nath Kovind in 2018. She was received by Lt. Governor of Ladakh, Brigadier B D Mishra, upon her arrival at Thoise airfield.

# Saudi Arabia's Ultimatum

## Saudi Arabia's Warning on Pakistani Begging Crisis

TPN, Nandi: When the name "Pakistan" comes to mind, it used to evoke thoughts of terrorism, but now it brings to mind the country's debt crisis. Pakistan is knocking on every door for loans and is struggling to sustain its government due to lack of funds. The economic situation in the country has become dire, with people suffering from food shortages and many fleeing to neighboring countries. Additionally, many Pakistanis are going to Saudi Arabia under the guise of pilgrimage. However, Saudi Arabia has expressed discontent regarding the behavior of these Pakistani pilgrims.

Recently, during the Saudi National Day celebrations on September 23, Pakistani leaders, including President Asif Ali Zardari, praised Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman and discussed strengthening diplomatic ties. chas, leading to complaints from Saudi citizens.

Saudi officials have repeatedly warned Pakistan about this issue, urging the government to take strong action against the trafficking of beggars. In response, Pakistan has initiated investigations and made several arrests, but the situation continues to be a source of embarrassment for both

nations. Saudi Arabia has warned that stricter measures may be taken against Pakistani pilgrims if the situation does not improve.

The ongoing economic turmoil in Pakistan has forced its citizens into desperate situations, pushing many to beg abroad, further damaging Pakistan's international reputation.

## French President Backs India for Permanent UN Security Council Membership



French President Emmanuel Macron has strongly endorsed India's bid for a permanent seat on a reformed United Nations Security Council (UNSC), alongside Germany, Japan, Brazil, and two African nations. Macron's call for reform comes amid growing global consensus on the need to reshape the UNSC to better reflect current geopolitical realities.

Speaking at the 79th session of the UN General Assembly in New York, Macron emphasized that the Security Council, often stymied by conflicting interests, needs to evolve. "Germany, Japan, India, and Brazil should be permanent members, as well as two countries that Africa would designate to represent it. New elected members should also be admitted," he said. Macron stressed that these changes would make the UN more effective and representative, ensuring it remains relevant in addressing modern global challenges.

Macron also advocated for limiting the use of veto power in cases of mass atrocities and improving the operational capabilities of the UNSC to maintain international peace and security. He expressed hope that these reforms would enhance the council's decision-making processes.

India's bid for permanent membership has gained increasing global support. US President Joe Biden reiterated Washington's backing during a recent bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov also called for better representation of developing countries in the council.

## Pakistan Braces for "Transitional Pain" as IMF Approves \$7 Billion Loan



Pakistan is preparing for economic "transitional pain" after the International Monetary Fund (IMF) approved a \$7 billion loan package aimed at stabilizing the country's faltering economy. The IMF announced an immediate disbursement of around \$1 billion as part of the deal, marking Pakistan's 24th IMF bailout since 1958.

Pakistan's Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb acknowledged the challenges ahead, stating that while the loan provides critical relief, the country must implement structural reforms to ensure this is the last IMF program it relies on. "There will be transitional pain, but if we are to make it the last programme, then we have to carry out structural reforms," Aurangzeb said in an interview with Geo News.

The three-year loan program from the IMF is contingent on Pakistan pursuing sound economic policies and reforms to foster more inclusive and resilient growth. Among the required reforms are unpopular measures, including reducing power subsidies and expanding Pakistan's narrow tax base.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on Thursday rejected calls for a 21-day ceasefire in the conflict with Hezbollah, ignoring a joint push by the United States, European Union, and several Arab states. The truce proposal followed a week of intense Israeli airstrikes on Hezbollah positions in Lebanon, which resulted in hundreds of deaths and the displacement of tens of thousands of civilians.

Netanyahu's office confirmed that the prime minister had not responded to the ceasefire request, which was spearheaded by US President Joe Biden, French President Emmanuel Macron, and other global allies. Instead, Netanyahu has instructed the Israeli army to "continue the fighting with full force" against the Lebanese militant group.

The joint call for a ceasefire was issued by Western powers, along with Japan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, and the United Arab Emirates, during meetings on the sidelines of the United Nations General Assembly in New York. The leaders expressed deep concern over the escalating violence, stating that the situation in Lebanon had become "intolerable" and that it was in the best interest of both Israelis and Lebanese civilians to halt the conflict.

"We call for an immediate 21-day ceasefire across the Lebanon-Israel border to provide space for diplomacy towards the conclusion of a diplomatic settlement," the joint statement said.

Despite these appeals, Israeli military actions intensified, with Israeli army chief Lieutenant General Herzi Halevi instructing soldiers to prepare for a potential ground offensive against Hezbollah. The group, in response, has launched rocket barrages into Israel and claimed to have targeted Tel Aviv with a ballistic missile.

## Indian Embassy in Beijing Requests Indian Nationals to Register for Consular Services

The Indian Embassy in Beijing has issued an advisory urging all Indian nationals, including students, residing in China to register with the mission to streamline and enhance the provision of consular services. This registration will be a mandatory requirement for availing of any future services from the embassy.

The advisory, issued on Thursday, provides options for registration through the embassy's website or by scanning a QR code. Alternatively, individuals can use the direct link [https://www.eoibeijing.gov.in/indian\_national\_registration] (https://www.eoibeijing.gov.in/indian\_national\_registration) to access the registration form.

Upon successful submission, a registration document containing the applicant's name, passport number, and registration number will be automatically generated and sent to the registered email ID. The embassy advised Indian nationals to keep this document handy, as it will need to be attached to future applications for consular services, including passport renewals, document attestations, police clearance certificates, and birth or marriage registrations. Failure to attach the registration document may result in delays in the processing of consular services, the advisory warned.

In the Nifty50 index, 41 companies gained while 9 lost. Maruti Suzuki, Grasim, Tata Motors, Shriram Finance, and Bajaj Finserv were the top gainers. On the other hand, Cipla, ONGC, L&T, Hero MotoCorp, and NTPC were

the biggest losers. All sectoral indices rose today except for consumer durables. Auto, finance, bank, media, IT, metal, and PSU bank indices saw gains.

Nifty support is at 26,000, and resistance is at 26,200. Investors can consider buying shares of Vedanta Limited, Grasim, Motherson, GAIL, and Punjab National Bank in the short term.

Paytm shares jumped 5% on heavy trading. Maury Tech has submitted its IPO papers with a valuation of Rs. 1,500 crore. Link Pencil has entered into a joint venture with Japan's Mitsubishi. Krasna Diagnostics acquired shares in Apulki Healthcare. Nifty Bank reached record highs with SBI and Kotak Bank leading the charge. Nifty auto and finance indices also jumped to new highs. Policybazaar shares fell to a one-month low after announcing it would not enter the healthcare sector. CLSA predicts that foreign institutional investment in domestic stock markets will increase, driven by expectations that the US Federal Reserve will further cut interest rates. Alcargo Gati announced a 10.2% increase in its distribution service costs starting in January. Shares of Five Star Business reached a four-month high.



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## Finance Ministry Supports REITs and E-Commerce in August Economic Review

In the August economic review released on September 26, the Finance Ministry extended its support to Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) and the e-commerce sector. The ministry highlighted that increased institutional participation and transparency have significantly contributed to the development of best practices within India's commercial real estate market.

The review noted that four existing listed REITs have played a crucial role in driving growth in stabilized commercial assets. The establishment of standardized market valuation processes and comprehensive REIT regulations has facilitated market-based approaches, enhancing overall sector efficiency.

Additionally, the ministry emphasized that legislative measures, including the Real Estate Regulation Act and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, have strengthened investor protection. ## Indian Bank to raise Rs 5,000 crore via infrastructure bonds

State-owned Indian Bank announced on September 26 that its board has approved a plan to raise Rs 5,000 crore through long-term infrastructure bonds to finance various projects. This approval allows the bank to issue additional bonds on top of the Rs 5,000 crore it has already raised in the current financial year (FY25).

According to a regulatory filing, the fundraising will occur in one or more tranches during the current or upcoming financial year. The proceeds will be used for financing or refinancing infrastructure projects and affordable housing, in compliance with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) guidelines and other relevant regulations.

In recent months, several state-run banks have turned to infrastructure bonds as



a funding source. For instance, Bank of Baroda successfully raised Rs 5,000 crore earlier this month at a coupon rate of 7.26 percent per annum through long-term 10-year infrastructure bonds. Similarly, the State Bank of India (SBI) raised Rs 10,000 crore through its fifth infrastructure bond issuance back in June.

The initiative by Indian Bank aims to strengthen its balance sheet while supporting the government's push for infrastructure development and affordable housing projects, which are crucial for economic growth. By tapping into the bond market, Indian Bank is positioning itself to meet increasing financing needs in these sectors, enhancing its role in the broader economic landscape.

## HDFC Bank Sells Housing Loan Portfolio Amid Regulatory Pressures

HDFC Bank Ltd. has taken significant steps to lighten its credit load by selling a housing loan portfolio worth approximately 60 billion rupees (\$717 million). This move comes in response to increasing regulatory pressures within the banking industry.

The sale was executed through private deals with around half a dozen state-controlled banks, as reported by sources familiar with the transactions, who requested anonymity due to the confidential nature of the information. Additionally, the bank has offloaded a car loan portfolio valued at about 90.6 billion rupees, which was securitized into a fixed income product known as pass-through certificates. These discussions to sell the car loan pool were previously reported in late August by Bloomberg, indicating nego-



tiations with roughly a dozen local asset management companies.

These transactions highlight HDFC Bank's strategy to reduce its retail loan portfolio as regulatory scrutiny intensifies regarding credit-deposit ratios. This ratio measures the proportion of a bank's deposits that are being lent out, and it has become

a focal point for regulators, especially as credit growth has outpaced deposit growth in India.

The bank's efforts are further underscored by its recent merger with Housing Development Finance Corp., which has also contributed to the pressures on its credit-deposit ratio. By offloading these loan portfolios, HDFC Bank aims to improve its financial metrics and ensure compliance with regulatory requirements.

As India's largest bank by market value, HDFC Bank's actions reflect a broader trend in the banking sector to adapt to changing regulatory landscapes. This proactive approach not only helps the bank manage its risk exposure but also positions it for sustainable growth in an evolving market.

## Sebi's Unified Distilled Filing Formats to Save Rs 200 Crores for Market Ecosystem

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) has introduced a new reporting system known as Unified Distilled Filing Formats (UDiFF), which is projected to save the market ecosystem an estimated Rs 200 crores over the next five years. This initiative aims to streamline the process of reporting, significantly easing the burden on brokerages and other market participants.



According to a press release from Sebi on September 26, the UDiFF will reduce reporting requirements by an impressive 90%. # SHOULD HINDU RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS BE FREED FROM STATE CONTROL?



The question of whether Hindu religious institutions should be freed from state control has sparked significant debate in India. This issue recently gained renewed attention following controversies such as the discovery of beef and fish oil in the Tirupati Laddu, one of the most sacred offerings in the country. The broader discussion revolves around the extent of government involvement in the administration of Hindu temples and their vast wealth, which some view as discriminatory compared to the relative autonomy enjoyed by religious institutions of other faiths.

## The Financial Power of Temples

Temples like the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD), Kerala's Sabarimala Temple, and Maharashtra's Shirdi Sai Baba Temple are among the wealthiest religious institutions in the world, attracting millions of devotees and generating enormous revenue. The Centre for Policy Studies estimated that Hindu temples collectively hold assets worth around ₹5 lakh crore. Religious tourism, driven largely by pilgrimages to these temples, contributes approximately 2.32% to India's GDP, according to a 2019 study by the National Institute of Public Finance and Policy (NIPFP).



Despite this immense financial clout, Hindu temples remain under significant government control. For example, the Tirupati temple, controlled by the state since 1933, generates an annual revenue of ₹3,000-₹4,000 crore, while the Shirdi Sai Baba Temple has generated around ₹29,000 crore since coming under government supervision in 1922. These figures reflect the substantial wealth managed by the state, raising concerns about whether government intervention is necessary or appropriate.

## Roots of State Control

State control of Hindu temples dates back to British colonial rule. The British, recognizing the economic power of these temples, implemented measures to manage their administration, primarily to safeguard temple wealth and align it with colonial interests. This system of control persisted post-independence, with the Indian government expanding its authority over temple administration. Laws like the Tamil Nadu Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Act of 1959 granted the government powers to appoint trustees, manage properties, and direct how temple funds should be allocated.



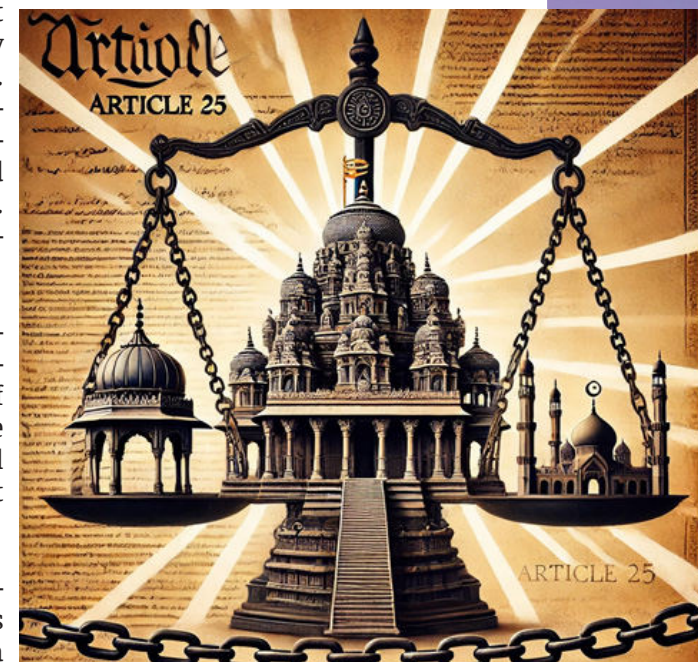
The rationale behind this intervention was to prevent mismanagement, corruption, and ensure that temple wealth contributed to public welfare in areas like education, healthcare, and infrastructure. However, this control has sparked controversy, with many Hindus questioning the fairness of this arrangement, especially when religious institutions belonging to other faiths are not subject to similar scrutiny.

## A Question of Equality and Religious Freedom

One of the primary arguments against government control of Hindu temples is the apparent disparity in how different religious institutions are treated. While Hindu temples are subject to strict government oversight, mosques and churches are managed by community boards, such as the Waqf Board for Muslims and diocesan authorities for Christians. These institutions enjoy significant financial autonomy, a privilege that Hindu temples do not share.

Hindu leaders and devotees have taken the matter to court on several occasions, though judicial rulings have largely upheld the government's right to intervene in temple administration.

The issue has also become politically sensitive. Hindu groups view state control of temple revenues as a sign of bias against the majority religion in a supposedly secular democracy. They question why Hindu institutions are the only ones under such strict government oversight, while religious institutions of minority communities remain largely free from state intervention.

In most democracies, religious institutions manage their own finances without state interference. For instance, in the United States and the United Kingdom, religious organisations, whether temples, churches, mosques, or synagogues, operate autonomously. India's unique approach to temple management raises questions about whether the state is genuinely maintaining a secular stance or perpetuating a system of unequal treatment between religions.

As renowned advocate Fali S. Nariman pointed out, *"While the state may regulate secular activities, the moment it interferes with the religious essence of an institution, it steps onto dangerous ground where constitutional rights can be trampled."* This sentiment resonates with many who believe that government control of Hindu temples infringes on religious freedom and undermines the community's right to manage its sacred institutions.

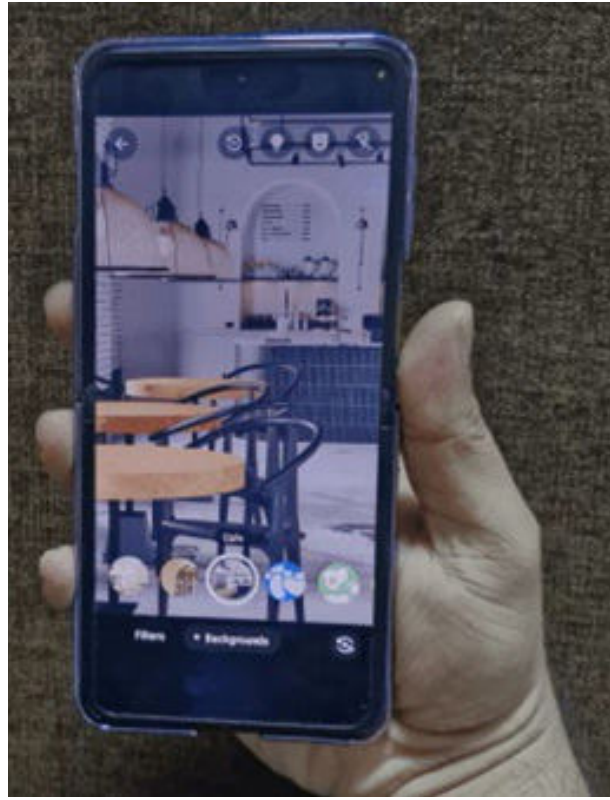

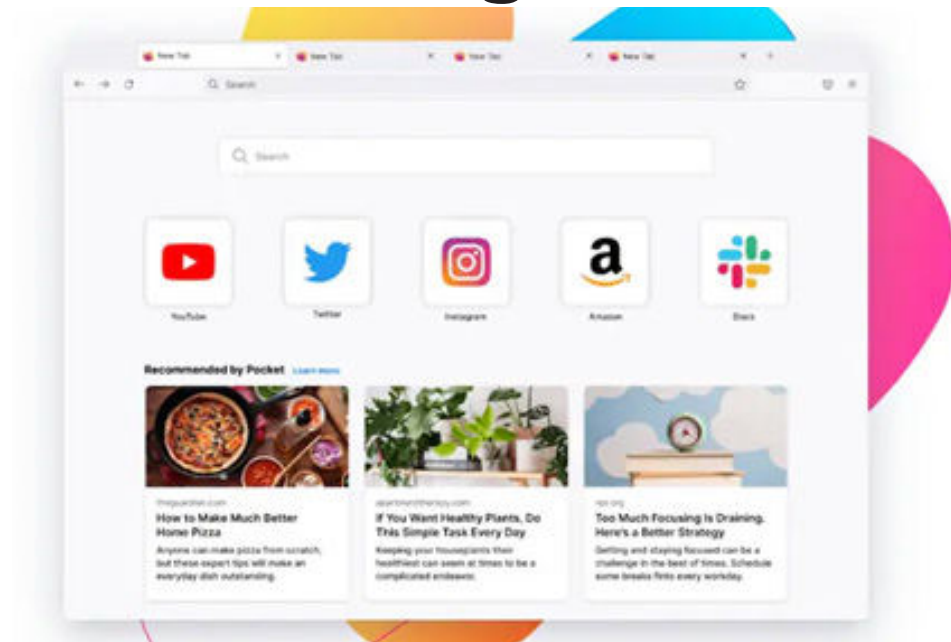
## Privacy Complaint Over Firefox User Tracking

Vienna-based advocacy group NOYB (None Of Your Business) announced on Wednesday that it has filed a complaint with the Austrian data protection authority against Mozilla. The complaint alleges that the Firefox browser is tracking user behavior on websites without proper consent.

NOYB, founded by privacy activist Max Schrems, claims that Mozilla has enabled a feature known as privacy preserving attribution (PPA) that effectively turns the browser into a tracking tool for websites. This feature was reportedly activated by default, which NOYB argues violates users' rights under EU privacy laws.

A spokesperson for Mozilla defended the PPA feature, stating, "Mozilla's limited test of PPA is a part of our effort to improve invasive advertising practices by providing technical alternatives." They emphasized that the technique is designed to prevent any party, including Mozilla, from identifying individuals or tracking their browsing activities.

However, NOYB contends that even though this method may be less invasive than unrestricted tracking, it still undermines user consent and rights. Felix Mikolasch, a data pro-



tection lawyer at NOYB, criticized Mozilla's approach, saying, "It's a shame that an organization like Mozilla believes that users are too dumb to say yes or no." He stressed that users should have the option to choose whether to participate in such tracking, calling for the feature to be turned off by default.

Once a popular choice among users for its privacy features, Firefox has seen its market share dwindle to low single digits compared to competitors like Google Chrome, Apple's Sa-

fari, and Microsoft's Edge.

In light of these allegations, NOYB is urging Mozilla to better inform users about its data processing practices, implement an opt-in system for the PPA feature, and delete all unlawfully processed data of affected users. This complaint follows NOYB's recent actions against Alphabet for similar tracking issues related to its Chrome browser, highlighting ongoing concerns about user privacy in digital environments.

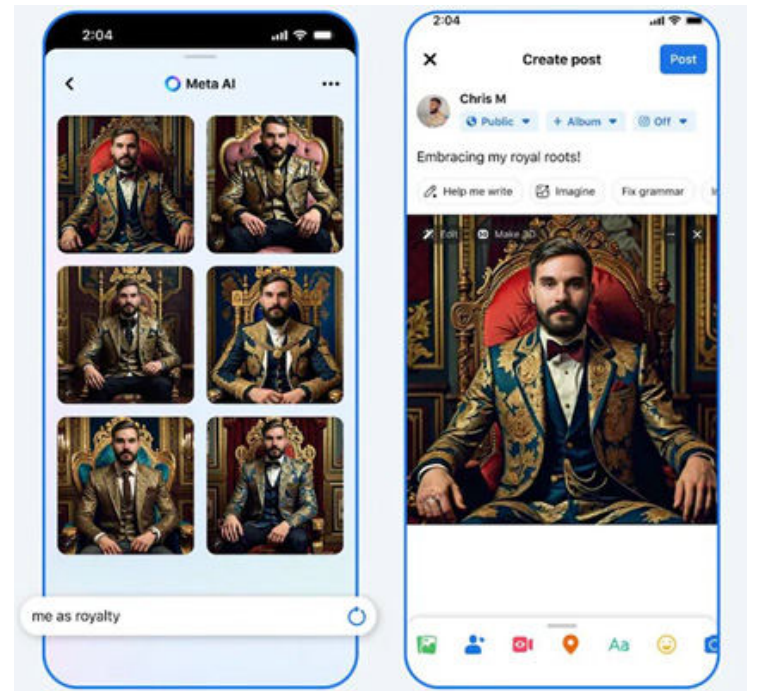

## Shakib Al Hasan Announces T20I Retirement



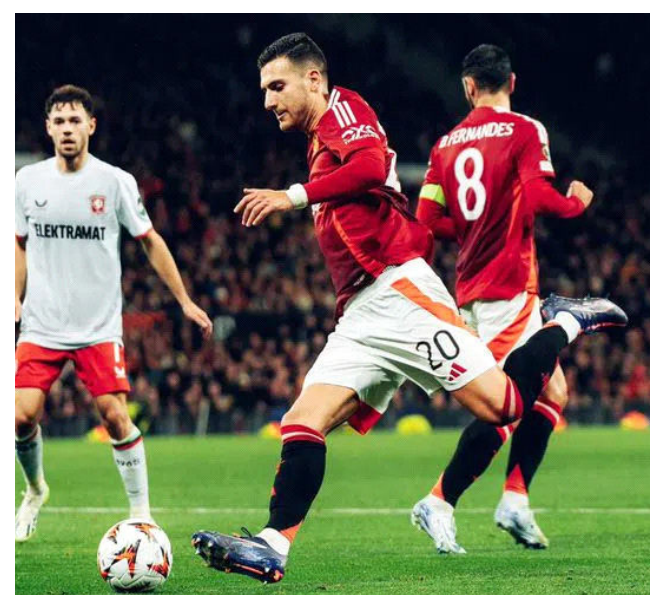

## Joaquin Phoenix and Lady Gaga Shine at UK Premiere of Joker

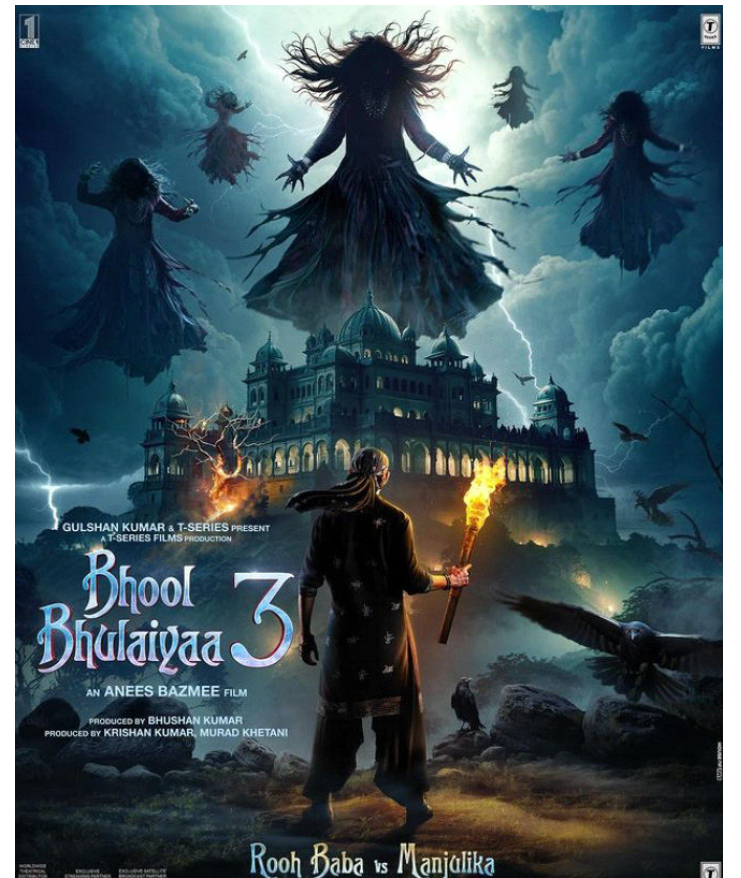
