TPN, Khammam: A violent clash erupted between Congress and BRS supporters in Khammam's Bokkalagadda area, where BRS leaders were visiting flood-affected victims. The incident occurred when BRS leaders, including Harish Rao, Puvvada Ajay Kumar, and Sabita Indra Reddy, arrived in the area to offer their support to those impacted by the recent floods.

At the same time, Congress leaders were also present in the area, leading to a confrontation between the two

their respective leaders, escalating the situation into a full-blown clash. Stones were thrown, resulting in damage to property and injuries.

In the midst of the chaos, former minister and BRS leader Puvvada Ajay Kumar's car was vandalized, with stones shattering the windows and causing significant damage. Several BRS leaders were injured in the attack, and one individual sustained a serious leg injury, requiring hospitalization.

In addition to his visit to Khammam, CM Revanth Reddy also toured the flood-affected Mahabubabad district. He informed the media that the state government has written to the Centre, seeking Rs. 2,000 crore in immediate financial assistance to address the damage, which has been initially estimated at Rs. 5,438 crore. A letter has also been sent to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, urging him to declare the floods in Telangana a national calamity.

The Chief Minister reiterated the state's commitment to supporting the affected families, announcing a compensation of Rs. 5 lakh for each family of the deceased.

### **Govt Issues Ordinance Merging 51** Villages into Municipalities Around ORR

TPN, Hyderabad: In a significant administrative move, the Telangana government has issued an ordinance to merge 51 villages located along the Hyderabad Outer Ring Road (ORR) into various municipalities. This merger affects villages across the districts of Rangareddy, Medchal-Malkajgiri, and Sangareddy, integrating them into their respective urban municipalities.

The ordinance includes the merger of varying numbers of villages into each municipality:

- + Pedda Amberpet Municipality: 4 villages have been merged.
- + Shamshabad Municipality: 6 villages have been merged.
- + Narsingi Municipality:1 village has been merged. + Tukkuguda Municipality:1 village has been merged.
- + Medchal Municipality:2 villages have been merged.
- + Dammaiguda Municipality: 6 villages have been merged.
- + Nagaram Municipality:5 villages have been merged.
- + Pocharam Municipality:5 villages have been merged. + Ghatkesar Municipality:6 villages have been merged.
- + Gundlapochampally Municipality:2 villages have been merged.

+ Tumkunta Municipality:3 villages have been merged.

This ordinance is part of state's broader efforts the streamline governance and enhance infrastructure development around the rapidly urbanizing areas of Hyderabad. The merger is expected to facilitate better delivery of municipal services and promote coordinated urban planning in these regions.

The inclusion of these villages into the municipalities is likely to bring changes in local administration, development projects, and civic amenities, potentially transforming these areas to keep pace with the expanding metropolis of Hyderabad.







### Telangana Suffers Rs. 5,438 Crore Loss Due to Heavy Rains

1,150 crores.

TPN, Telangana: Telangana has been severely impacted by relentless heavy rains, with the state experiencing widespread devastation, particularly in the combined districts of Warangal, Khammam, and Nalgonda. The rains have caused significant damage to infrastructure, agriculture, and public utilities, leaving the state grappling with a massive estimated loss of Rs. 5,438 crores.

Farmers have borne the brunt of this natural calamity, with vast acres of crops destroyed. In many areas, sand dunes have overtaken fertile fields, and the flooding of the left canal of Nagarjunasagar has submerged large swathes of farmland. The damage to crops alone is estimated at Rs. 415 crores, and officials warn continue.



The Roads and Buildings Department reported severe damage to infrastructure, with roads and bridges across the state being compromised. The estimated loss in this sector alone is Rs. that this figure could rise as assessments 2,362 crores. The damage extends to the power sector, where broken pillars and cut power lines

have resulted in a loss of Rs. 175 crores. Other sectors have also faced substantial damage: the Irrigation Department has reported losses of Rs. 629 crores, Panchayati Raj & Rural Development losses of Rs. 170 crores, the Medical and Health Department has incurred Rs. 12 crores in damages, the Animal Husbandry Department has reported Rs. 25 crores in losses, and the Municipal Administration has faced a significant hit with an estimated loss of Rs.

#### Death Toll Rises to 16; State Seeks ₹2,000 Crore Assistance

The severe flooding in Telangana has led to a rising death toll, now at 16, with several individuals still missing as search and rescue operations continue. The catastrophic floods, which have severely disrupted normal life

across multiple districts, have caused extensive damage, estimated by the state government to be around ₹5,000 crore. In response, the state has urgently requested ₹2,000 crore in immediate financial aid from the central government to aid in recovery and relief efforts.

In Khammam, the situation is particularly severe. The Munneru River has overflowed, submerging at least 15 residential colonies and affecting over 100 villages. The towns of Bokkalagadda, Moti Nagar, and Damsalapuram have been especially hard hit, with residents grappling with floodwaters that have inundated their homes. Efforts to salvage belongings are underway, but many areas are still without power and access to clean drinking water, compounding the challenges faced by the affected residents.

## Telangana Government Employees Donate ₹132 Crores for Flood Relief

TPN, Telangana: Telangana govern ment employees have pledged a generous donation of ₹132 crores to aid flood victims across the state. This announcement comes in response to the severe impact of recent heavy rains, which have led to widespread flooding, particularly in the combined Khammam district. The deluge has left many residents without access to food and clean water, trapping them in dire conditions.

On Tuesday morning, the Joint Action Committee (JAC) of Telangana Government Employees announced that its members will contribute one day's basic pay to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund. This substantial contribution reflects the collective commitment of various categories of employees, including gazetted officers, teachers, laborers, contract workers, outsourcing staff, and pensioners.

### **Health Minister Reviews** Medicare Service Act, Focuses on Hospital Security



Damodar Raja Narasimha conducted a review of the Telangana Medicare Service Act, 2008, on September 2, emphasizing the need for enhanced security in government hospitals across the state. The review was aimed at ensuring better protection for healthcare staff, particularly women doctors and nurses.

During the meeting, the minister stressed the importance of adhering to the Supreme Court's directive to appoint hospital safety committees. He directed the health department to review and report on all cases registered under Section 11 of the Telangana Medicare Service Act. Additionally, he proposed the establishment of fast-track courts in the state's 10 joint districts to expedite the resolution of these cases, ensuring swift justice.

TPN, Telangana: Telangana Health Minister Minister Raja Narasimha also instructed officials to tighten security measures in government hospitals, with a particular focus on protecting women staff members. He called for the creation of police outposts across all teaching hospitals in Telangana and confirmed that space has already been allocated for such outposts in the Telangana Institute of Medical Sciences (TIMS) hospitals.

> Furthermore, he emphasized that private security agencies working in hospitals must be accredited under the PSAR (Private Security Agency – Regulations) Act, 2015. The minister urged the coordination of efforts between the health and police departments, including the installation of CCTV cameras connected to local police stations, to strengthen hospital security from Primary Health Centers (PHC) to area hospitals.

## Telangana **Faces Another Cyclone Threat**

TPN, Telangana: The state of Telangana is bracing for yet another potential disaster as the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a warning about the formation of a new low-pressure system in the Bay of Bengal. Expected to form on the 5th of this month, this system poses a significant threat to the Telugu states, with the IMD predicting heavy rains and possible flooding.

According to IMD officials, the low-pressure area is developing near North Andaman and is likely to intensify into a cyclone. The storm is projected to make landfall between North Andhra and South Odisha, potentially bringing severe weather conditions to Telangana.

Telangana is already reeling from recent floods that have inundated several districts, including Khammam, Adilabad, Suryapet, and Nalgonda. Many villages remain waterlogged, with residents being relocated to rehabilitation centers as the state government provides necessary aid.

The IMD has forecasted that the impact of this weather system will be felt over the next two to three days, with rains expected to lash several districts across Telangana. Adilabad, Asifabad, Nirmal, Nizamabad, Sangareddy, Medak, Kamareddy, Jagityala, and parts of Malkajgiri and Siddipet are among the districts likely to experience heavy rainfall.

With 11 districts across the state predicted to receive aboveaverage rainfall, the situation remains critical. Authorities are on standby, ready to implement further precautionary measures to protect lives and property as Telangana faces this looming threat.

### **CM** Revanth Reddy Announces district-wise **Hydra System**

TPN, Mahabubabad: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy made a series of imannouncements pactful during his visit to flood-affected areas, signaling a robust response to the recent natural calamity. Speaking at a meeting held at the District Collectorate of Mahabubabad, CM Revanth Reddy emphasized the urgent need for support from the central government and outlined his administration's plans to prevent future disasters.

As the state continues to grapple with the aftermath of severe flooding, CM Revanth Reddy urged the cen-

tral government to immediately release ₹2,000 crores in relief funds. He acknowledged that while state officials and ministers had been vigilant, the scale of the damage was significant. "Despite our efforts, the floods have caused substantial damage to both government and private properties," he noted, praising the prompt actions of revenue and police officials that minimized the loss of life.

The Chief Minister also called for the flood disaster in Telangana to be declared a national calamity, highlighting the extensive agricultural damage with an estimated 30,000 acres of crops destroyed across the state. He further mentioned that he has invited the Prime Minister to personally assess the flood damage in Telangana.



In a key part of his address, CM Revanth Reddy spoke about the Hydra system—a mechanism designed to prevent the encroachment of ponds and other water bodies, which he attributed as a factor contributing to the recent flooding. He reassured the public that, despite challenges and pressures, the Hydra system would continue to advance, ensuring that such natural calamities are mitigated in the future.

The Chief Minister announced plans to extend the Hydra system to districts across the state, reinforcing the government's commitment to safeguarding public assets and cracking down on illegal land encroachments. "Those who have occupied pond lands will not be spared," he warned, underlining the government's determination to take stringent action against violators.

## **Attack on BRS Leaders: Jagadish Reddy Alleges Pre-Planned Assault**

TPN, Telangana: Former minister Jagadish Reddy has claimed that the attack on BRS leaders in Khammam was premeditated, orchestrated by Congress supporters. The attack occurred during a visit by BRS leaders, including Puvwada Ajay Kumar, to flood-affected areas in the district. Stones were thrown at Ajay Kumar's vehicle, and several BRS leaders were injured. Speaking at the Khammam BRS office on Tuesday, Jagadish Reddy condemned the violence and criticized the state government for its failure to respond to the flood crisis effectively.

Reddy argued that the attack was planned in advance, with Congress supporters acting before the police arrived. He demanded swift action against the attackers, accusing the Congress party of engaging in "petty politics" to cover up their governance failures. He added that despite the floods, ministers remained inactive, waking only when prompted by the people. Reddy reiterated the need for compensation for the flood victims and accused the government of deceiving the public.

## Set up health camps, repair damaged roads: GHMC commissioner

**Hyderabad:** Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) Commissioner Amrapali Kata has issued directives for immediate action to address the flooding and canal maintenance issues plaguing the city. During a teleconference on Tuesday morning, September 3, the Commissioner stressed the need for swift measures to clear floating debris from canals and stormwater drain culverts during dry periods to ensure proper drainage and prevent water stagnation.

Commissioner Kata emphasized the importance of special initiatives during the rainy season to manage water accumulation and prevent flooding in vulnerable areas. The Additional Commissioner of Health has been tasked with identifying flood-affected colonies for the implementation of anti-larvae operations and fogging to curb the spread of seasonal diseases. Additionally, health camps are to be set up in collaboration with district medical officers in the Rangareddy, Hyderabad, and Medchal districts.



Addressing the infrastructure damage caused by the rains, the Commissioner ordered the immediate repair of roads damaged by the floods. She also directed the installation of warning boards or barricades around particularly hazardous areas to prevent accidents.

Following the teleconference, Commissioner Kata conducted a surprise inspection in the Kukatpally zone, including flood-affected areas like Maisamma Pond, IDL Pond, and Safdar Nagar. During her inspection, she stressed the urgency of completing canal works to prevent further disruptions from flooding and advised on the provision of safe drinking water to affected residents.

This comes as Telangana has suffered significant losses due to recent heavy rains and floods, with an estimated total damage of Rs. 5,438 crore, according to a report released by the Telangana CMO. The report details extensive damage across multiple sectors, including roads, buildings, energy, irrigation, and public properties. In response, 110 relief camps have been organized, safely relocating over 4,000 people.

The situation remains critical, particularly in areas like Khammam's Prakash Nagar, where the water level of the Munneru River has risen due to continuous rainfall. The GHMC's ongoing efforts aim to mitigate the impact of the floods and ensure the safety and wellbeing of Hyderabad's residents.

### Telangana Health **Minister Makes Surprise Visit to** Gandhi Hospital



TPN, Secunderabad: Telangana Minister Damodar Raja Narasimha conducted an unannounced visit to Gandhi Hospital in Secunderabad on the morning of September 3, catching both officials and visitors off guard. The minister's visit was aimed at inspecting the hospital's preparedness in combating the surge of seasonal diseases, including dengue, chikungunya, norovirus, and malaria.

During his visit, Minister Raja Narasimha met with the hospital superintendent, Dr. Rajkumari, to review the current status of the hospital's operations. He inquired about the duty reports of nursing staff and duty doctors, as well as the diagnostic data maintained by the hospital.

The surprise visit prompted immediate attention from other senior health officials, including the State Medical Health Secretary, Dr. Christina, and the Special Officer of State Medical Education, Dr. N. Vani, who joined the minister to assist in the inspection.

Telangana, particularly Hyderabad, is experiencing a worrying increase in seasonal diseases, with 163 dengue cases reported out of 5,294 samples tested across the state on August 31 alone. The state has also seen a rise in chikungunya cases, with 152 more cases reported this year compared to previous years. Experts have raised concerns about the decreasing effectiveness of fogging in controlling mosquito breeding.

In response to the surge in cases, the government is intensifying its prevention efforts. Special beds, IV fluids, and essential medicines are being provided at public health facilities, while ORS sachets are being distributed through ANMs, ASHAs, and Anganwadi workers to manage potential emergencies.

The minister's surprise visit underscores the government's commitment to ensuring that public health facilities are fully equipped to handle the ongoing health challenges posed by the seasonal disease outbreak.

## DCA raids medical store in Tarnaka, seizes expired drugs



TPN, Secunderabad: On Monday, September 2, officials from the Drugs Control Administration (DCA) conducted a raid on Kandar Medicals,

During the raid, the DCA officials seized nine varieties of physician's samples, six varieties of expired drugs, and one institutional supply drug, with a total value of Rs. 55,000. Physician's samples are typically manufactured by pharmaceutical companies to be distributed to doctors, who in turn provide them to patients for free. These samples are not intended for sale, making their presence in a retail outlet

The raid was carried out by a team of DCA officials, including D. Saritha, Assistant Director (Secunderabad), B. Govind Singh, Drugs Inspector (Secunderabad), G. Anil, Drugs Inspector (Malakpet), P. Renuka, Drugs Inspector (Musheerabad), and M. Surendranath, Drugs Inspector (Begumpet).

Further investigation is underway, and legal action will be pursued against all individuals involved in the illegal activities at Kandar Medicals, as per the provisions of the law.

### HYDRA Demolishes 10 Illegal **Buildings in Ameenpur**



TPN, Ameenpur: The Hyderabad Disaster Response and Asset Protection Agency (HYDRA) continued its crackdown on illegal constructions on Tuesday, September 3, demolishing 10 buildings in Ameenpur. The structures, located in survey number 462, were found to be built on encroached land within the full tank level (FTL) and buffer zones around local lakes.

Among the demolished buildings were several linked to the local municipal commissioner, Tummala Panduranga Reddy. Despite his attempts to halt the demolition, including a

verbal confrontation with HYDRA authorities and the use of lorries to block their path, the buildings were flattened after being identified as illegal encroachments.

HYDRA's actions are part of an ongoing effort to clear illegal structures that pose environmental and safety risks in and around the city's water bodies. The demolitions in Ameenpur involved clearing structures spread across over 20 guntas of

Tahsildar Radha confirmed that prior notices were issued to the landowners before the demolition began, ensuring that the legal process was followed. The demolitions have sparked significant attention, particularly given the involvement of a high-ranking local official in the encroachments.

The HYDRA operation underscores the government's commitment to enforcing land use regulations and protecting the city's natural resources from unauthorized development.

The petitioners submitted the required documents on August 13, 2024, but despite this, the municipal authorities proceeded with partial demolitions of

that favored their position. They referenced a similar issue from May 2015, when they had received similar notices claiming their properties were within the FTL or buffer zone of Osmansagar lake. At that time, a joint inspection by the Irrigation and Command Area Development authorities, along with revenue officials, confirmed that their properties were outside the FTL contour, set at 1,790 feet. This finding was

documented in a September 7, 2015 report, which contradicted the current claims made by municipal officials.

Considering the petitioners' arguments and the previous inspection report supporting their claims, Justice T. Vinod Kumar directed the state government to provide all relevant Osmansagar reservoir records within three weeks. The case is scheduled for its next hearing on September 23,





### **India And China May Finally** Be Warming Up To Each Other

In recent months, there have been subtle but significant developments in the relationship between India and China, particularly in the context of ongoing border tensions and economic engagement. While it's too early to declare a full thaw in relations, the diplomatic exchanges and policy shifts suggest a cautious warming trend.

#### Diplomatic Engagements: A Softening Tone?

July witnessed a renewed diplomatic dialogue between India and China, marked by two meetings between Indian External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar and China's top diplomat, Wang Yi. Notably, the first of these meetings signaled a softer tone from Beijing, with Wang Yi refraining from his usual remarks about putting the border issue in the "appropriate position." Instead, he emphasized the importance of "properly handling and controlling the situation in the border areas, while actively resuming normal exchanges."

The second meeting reinforced this shift, with the Chinese statement highlighting the need to "work for new progress in consultations on border affairs." This led to two meetings of the Working Mechanism for Consultation & Coordination on India-China Border Affairs within a month, the most recent of which took place last week.

The Chinese readout following these discussions was notably positive. It stated that both sides had "agreed to work together to turn over a new leaf in the border situation at an early date," indicating a narrowing of differences and an expansion of consensus. In contrast, the Indian readout was more restrained, focusing on the "frank, constructive and forward-looking exchange of views" aimed at narrowing differences and finding an early resolution to the outstanding issues along the Line of Actual Control (LAC). The effectiveness of these discussions in resolving the disputes in Depsang and Demchok remains to be seen.

#### **Reconsidering Economic Engagement with China**

Simultaneously, India is witnessing a renewed debate on economic engagement with China. The Economic Survey released ahead of the new NDA government's budget in July hinted at a possible reopening of doors to Chinese investments. This marks a significant shift from the stringent scrutiny that Chinese investments have faced since the issuance of Press Note 3 in April 2020,

which was seen as an effort to direct Chinese capital into desirable sectors. The situation further deteriorated following the Galwan Valley clashes in June 2020, which effectively froze any appetite for Chinese investments in India.

However, recent reports suggest a gradual easing of these restrictions. Since April 2020, the Indian government has approved 124 investment proposals from bordering countries, many of which are from China, while rejecting 201. A significant number of proposals remain pending. This cautious reopening is exemplified by the March 2024 joint venture between MG Motor India and JSW Group, where Chinese auto giant SAIC Motor divested a 51% stake. Moreover, in July, the government notified electronics and automobile manufacturers about plans to establish an inter-ministerial panel to accelerate the approval process for Chinese investments.

#### **Balancing Pragmatism with** Caution

India's approach to Chinese capital is marked by pragmatism, recognizing the importance of Chinese investments in boosting India's manufacturing sector and integrating with global value chains. Yet, this pragmatism is tempered by caution. External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar recently emphasized the need for scrutiny of Chinese investments, given the geopolitical challenges and security concerns. He called for a structured investment review mechanism with clear guidelines, conditions, and timelines to ensure predictability and democratic oversight.

However, working with Chinese entities remains fraught with risks. The volatility in India-China relations, deeply rooted in structural fault lines, means that political and security considerations will always take precedence. As a result, the risks for Indian industry in engaging with Chinese capital are likely to remain high.

#### Charting a Clear Path Forward

As India navigates this complex relationship, it is crucial for its political and strategic communities to deliberate on the desired contours of its relationship with China. While many have called for a new modus vivendi, there is a need for deeper reflection on what this new state of affairs should look like and how India can achieve it. Only through purposeful and pragmatic policy can India hope to manage its delicate relationship with China effectively.

### How PMJDY Sparked a Ripple **Effect Across India's Economy**

The Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY), launched on August 28, 2014, stands as a transformative initiative in India's journey towards financial inclusion. Much like the Marshall Plan of 1948 that revitalized postwar Europe, PMJDY has created a significant ripple effect across India's economy by bringing millions of people into the formal banking system. This inclusion has not only enhanced economic participation but also contributed to poverty reduction and social stability.

#### A Catalyst for Financial Inclusion

The PMJDY aimed to integrate 7.5 crore unbanked households into the formal financial system through the JAM (Jan Dhan, Aadhar, Mobile) trinity. By August 2024, more than 80% of Indian adults had formal financial accounts, a significant increase from around 50% in 2011. Public sector banks, which manage 78% of PMJDY accounts, have opened approximately 53 crore accounts with total balances amounting to ₹2.31 lakh crore. Notably, 55.6% of these accounts belong to women, and 66.6% are in rural and semi-urban areas, underscoring the scheme's broad reach and social impact.

The increase in average account balances from ₹1,065 in March 2015 to ₹4,352 in August 2024 indicates a growing trust and reliance on formal banking channels. The program has also been linked to social benefits, including reductions in thefts and decreased consumption of intoxicants in states with higher account penetration.

access has empowered individuals to invest in education, health, and businesses, leading to improved economic outcomes.

The PMJDY, coupled with the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), has significantly impacted India's micro and small enterprises. Since its inception in 2015, the PMMY has provided over ₹27.75 lakh crore in loans to 47 crore entrepreneurs, with 69% of these loans going to women and 51% to SC/ST and OBC entrepreneurs. This has promoted financial inclusion and social equity while supporting job creation, particularly in rural and semi-urban areas.

By allowing instant money transfers between bank accounts via mobile phones, UPI has drastically reduced transaction costs and eliminated the need for physical banking infrastructure. As a result, millions who were previously excluded from the formal financial system now have access to efficient and convenient financial services.

### **Employee Property Declarations**

The Uttar Pradesh government has extended the deadline for its employees to submit their property details by one month. This extension applies to the mandatory requirement for all officers and employees of the state government to register their immovable and movable assets for the 2023-2024 financial year on the departmental evaluation portal, Manav Sampada.

The original deadline for submitting these details was August 31. However, with only 74% of the state's 1.78 million government employees having complied by that date, the government decided to provide an additional month for the remaining employees to fulfill this obligation. The decision was announced by Shishir, the Director of the Department of Information and Public Relations.

The Manav Sampada portal is an integrated human resource management system developed to streamline and digitize various HR processes within government departments. This platform plays a critical role in managing tasks such as recruitment, postings, promotions, and transfers, ensuring a more efficient and transparent administrative process.

For the current financial year, the state government has made it compulsory for all its employees to disclose their property holdings on this portal. This move is part of

#### broader efforts to enhance transparency and accountability within the public service.

It's important for employees to note that failing to register their property details on the Manav Sampada portal could have serious consequences. According to the directives, any employee who does not submit their asset information within the extended deadline will be marked as absent. As a result, they will not receive their monthly salary, adding significant

urgency to comply with this requirement.

### Congress and AAP Reach Agreement for Haryana Assembly Election Alliance

The Congress and Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) have reached an "in-principal understanding" to jointly contest the upcoming Haryana Assembly elections, sources revealed on Tuesday. This alliance, which aims to consolidate opposition votes against the ruling BJP, has entered a critical phase of seatsharing negotiations.

The AAP has reportedly requested 10 out of the 90 seats, but Congress is inclined to offer only five to seven, while also considering one seat for the Samajwadi Party. Key figures like AAP's Rajya Sabha MP Raghav Chadha and Congress General Secretary KC Venugopal are expected to meet soon to finalize the arrangement, with the nomination deadline set for October 4 and voting on October 5.

The alliance reflects a broader strategy within the INDIA bloc, led by Congress, to avoid vote splitting in the 2024 general elections. In the 2024 Haryana Lok Sabha election, Congress and AAP contested on



a 9:1 seat-sharing ratio, with Congress winning five seats and AAP losing its sole contest in Kurukshetra. This collaboration is seen as crucial for maintaining the

momentum from the bloc's strong performance in recent elections and challenging the BJP's dominance in Haryana.

### **Gadkari Advocates 51%** Foreign Stake in Tunnel **Projects for Improved Quality**

Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari on Tuesday advocated for a 51 percent stake to be given to foreign partners in joint for building tunnels and preparing Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) in India. This, he believes, is essential to ensure that only serious and technically qualified companies bid for such infrastructure projects, thereby improving the quality of work.

Speaking at an event, Gadkari emphasized the importance of allowing foreign firms to take the lead in joint ventures to prevent substandard practices. In a light-hearted remark, he noted that in some tunnel projects, companies European partnered have Indian firms that have no experience in construction,

such as those providing catering services or running beauty parlours.

"I seriously feel that foreign partners must have 51 percent stake, leaving 49 percent for the Indian companies in JV for building DPR and construction of tunnels, to ensure that work is done properly," Gadkari said, stressing the need for technical competence in such

Known for his straightforward views, Gadkari also criticized the current state of DPRs, referring to their creators as says has contributed to the increasing 22.



incidence of landslides in India, particularly in Uttarakhand and other Himalayan regions. He called for a permanent solution to address these issues, which have become more frequent.

Gadkari also highlighted the economic implications of reducing logistics costs, suggesting that if India could lower its logistics costs to 9 percent, it could boost exports by 1.5 times. Current estimates by the National Council of Applied Economic Research indicate that logistics costs in India ranged from "culprits" for poor oversight, which he 7.8 percent to 8.9 percent of GDP in 2021-

#### **CM Yogi Adityanath** Slams Samajwadi **Party for Corruption** and Anarchy in **Mainpuri Address**

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath launched a scathing attack on the Samajwadi Party (SP) during an address in Mainpuri on Tuesday, accusing the party of fostering corruption, anarchy, and hooliganism during its tenure. Adityanath claimed that these issues are "ingrained in the DNA" of the SP, led by Akhilesh Yadav. Highlighting Mainpuri's lag in development, Adityanath questioned why the district, once considered VVIP, faced an identity crisis. He attributed this to the "deeds" of the SP, referencing a case in Kannauj where former SP leader Nawab Singh Yadav was arrested for raping a teenager. Adityanath used this incident to criticize the SP's governance, stating, "Their model is not of development but

The Chief Minister further alleged that under the SP's rule, jobs were auctioned off, with Akhilesh Yadav and his uncle Shivpal Singh Yadav—whom Adityanath referred to as "Chacha-Bhatija"—engaging in extortion. He accused them of being more concerned about personal gain than the welfare of Mainpuri and Etawah.

Adityanath also accused the SP of banning Janmashtami celebrations in the past, contrasting this with his government's promotion of the festival in all police stations and prisons across the state. He emphasized his commitment to respecting Hindu faith, citing the construction of the Kashi Vishwanath Dham and a grand temple of Ramlalla in Ayodhya.

Concluding his address, Adityanath announced new projects worth Rs 375 crore for the people of the Karhal assembly constituency, reaffirming his government's focus on development.

### BJP's Rajib Bhattacharjee Wins Tripura's Lone Rajya Sabha Seat



Rajib Bhattacharjee, the state president of the BJP in Tripura, secured the state's lone Rajya Sabha seat on Tuesday, defeating CPI(M) candidate Sudhan Das by a margin of 37 votes. Bhattacharjee received support from 47 MLAs, while Das garnered 10 votes. The Congress, which holds three seats in the 60-member assembly, abstained from voting.

Deputy Speaker Ramprasad Paul confirmed Bhattacharjee's victory, noting that all members of the ruling alliance backed the BJP nominee. Expressing his gratitude, Bhattacharjee thanked the legislators who supported him, as well as Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, and BJP national president J.P. Nadda for their trust in him.

"I am thankful to all those MLAs who have supported me in the election and also extend special thanks to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, and BJP national president for keeping faith in me," Bhattacharjee said. Bhattacharjee, who had previously contested and lost in last year's assembly elections, vowed to focus on the development of Tripura and its people as a member of the Rajya Sabha. His victory solidifies the BJP's influence in the state, where it has maintained a stronghold in recent years.

This win comes at a crucial time as the BJP continues to strengthen its position across the northeastern states, ahead of the 2024 general elections. Bhattacharjee's commitment to the state's development is expected to play a significant role in furthering the party's agenda in the region.

#### Ex-Principal of RG Kar Medical College Arrested by CBI, Sent to 8-Day Custody

Sandip Ghosh, the former principal of RG Kar Medical College, has been sent to eight days of police custody following his arrest by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on charges of financial irregularities. Ghosh, who is also under scrutiny for his role in the investigation of a 31-year-old doctor's rape and murder at the college on August 9, was arrested alongside three others.

The CBI, which had sought 10 days of custody, made the arrest in connection with alleged financial mismanagement during Ghosh's tenure as principal. The other arrested individuals include vendors Biplav Singha and Suman Hazara, who supplied medicine to the hospital, and Afsar Ali, a security guard.

Ghosh's role in the aftermath of the woman doctor's death has been widely criticized. The Supreme Court questioned why, as head of the institution, he did not immediately file a First Information Report (FIR).

His hasty transfer to another hospital following his resignation under public pressure also drew significant scrutiny, leading the Calcutta High Court to suggest he take a leave of absence instead.

### Kolkata: Junior Doctors End 24-Hour Standoff, Demand Police Chief's Resignation


A 24-hour standoff between junior doctors and the Kolkata Police concluded this afternoon as police succumbed to public pressure, removing barricades that had blocked a protest march to the police headquarters in Lalbazar. The protest was sparked by the mishandling of the case involving the rape and murder of a woman doctor at a local hospital last month.

The protesters, carrying a symbolic spinal cord, demanded the resignation of the police chief, whom they accused of negligence. The medics had placed the spine replica on the barricades to underscore the police's duty to protect citizens. "Our agitation will continue until we meet the Commissioner of Police," a doctor told the Press Trust of India.

The protest began yesterday after the arrest of Sandip Ghosh, the former principal of the hospital where the crime occurred. The junior doctors, who had been blocked from reaching Lalbazar, staged a sit-down protest a kilometer away from the police headquarters. The demonstration gained momentum as civil society members joined in, leading to the eventual removal of the barricades.

The doctors accused the police of negligence and even suggested a cover-up, pointing to the misinformation given to the victim's parents. Initially, the parents were told their daughter was unwell, and later, that she had committed suicide—a claim made by the hospital's assistant superintendent.

The partially clothed body of the young woman was discovered in the hospital's seminar room on August 9, causing public outrage. The delay in filing an FIR and the insensitive comments by Sandip Ghosh further fueled the protests. Multiple protest marches are now taking place across the city.

### Russian Missile Strike in Poltava Kills 41, Injures Over 180 in Ukraine

Poltava, Ukraine: A devastating Russian missile strike in Ukraine's Poltava region has left at least 41 people dead and more than 180 injured. The attack, which occurred today, targeted a military education facility, a hospital, and an educational institution. According to Ukraine's Ministry of Defence, two Russian ballistic missiles hit the area, partially destroying one of the institute's buildings.

"The time interval between the alarm and the arrival of the deadly missiles was so short that it caught people in the middle of evacuating to the bomb shelter," the Ministry of Defence

President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, in a social media post, confirmed the attack, noting that many people remain trapped under the debris. He expressed deep condolences to the victims' families and praised the efforts of rescue teams who have been working tirelessly to save lives.

The Ukrainian President has ordered a full-scale investigation into the circumstances surrounding the attack and reiterated his call for international support. "We continue to urge everyone in the world who has the power to stop this terror: Ukraine needs air defense systems and missiles now, not sitting in storage. Long-range strikes that can protect us from Russian terror are needed now, not later," Zelenskyy wrote.

Describing the incident as a "terror attack," Zelenskyy vowed that Russia will "surely pay for this strike." Rescue operations are ongoing as the nation mourns the tragic loss of life.

### **Elon Musk Supports** Trump's Plan to Audit US **Agencies, Citing Waste** and Regulation

Tesla CEO Elon Musk has confirmed his eagerness to collaborate with former President Donald Trump on an initiative to audit US government agencies and identify programs for potential cuts. Musk responded to a report by The Washington Post on X, stating, "I can't wait. There is a lot of waste and needless regulation in government that needs to go."

Trump, the Republican nominee for the 2024 Presidential election, is preparing to establish a commission dedicated to evaluating federal agencies and pinpointing areas for cost reduction. The proposed commission is expected to include prominent business leaders such as Fred Smith, former CEO of FedEx, and Robert Nardelli, former CEO of Home Depot, according to The Washington Post.

Musk's interest in government efficiency is not new. Last month, he posted an AI-generated image of himself at a "Department of Government Efficiency" lectern, indicating his enthusiasm for contributing to such efforts.

While Trump has recognized Musk's potential value as a consultant, some ethics experts are wary of potential conflicts of interest between Musk's business ventures and the commission's goals.

Inspired by past initiatives led by Ronald Reagan and Tom Coburn, Trump's advisers are aiming to recruit high-profile business figures to address federal waste. Musk's increasing political involvement, including hiring a Republican strategist and conducting a recent live interview with Trump on his platform X, underscores his growing influence. Trump has praised Musk, describing him as "fantastic" and "brilliant."

### **Markets Pause After 13-Day Rally Amid Lackluster Global Cues: Sectoral Rotation Observed**

The streak of gains in the domestic stock market ended as the 13-session rally came to a pause. On Tuesday, the indices closed flat due to a lack of cues from international markets, leading to cautious investor sentiment. Nifty inched up by just one point, while Sensex dipped by 4 points, reflecting a rangebound market with low trading volumes. Private banks and insurance companies provided some positive momentum. The market breadth was balanced, with 2,011 stocks advancing and 1,925 declining. The rupee weakened by 5 paise, closing at 83.97 against the dollar.



The BSE Sensex, which previclosed at 82,559, opened at 82,652 and fluctuated between an intraday low of 82,400 and a high of 82,675, eventually closing at 82,555. The NSE Nifty opened at 25,313, hitting a low of 25,235 and a high of 25,321 before closing at 25,279, up by just 1 point. Nifty Bank gained 249 points to settle at 51,689.

Among the Nifty50, 21 companies advanced while 29 declined. SBI Life, Bajaj Finserv, ICICI Bank, HDFC Life, and Hero MotoCorp were the top gainers, while Bajaj Finance, ONGC, Infosys, Adani Ports, and HCL Tech led the losers. Sector-wise, auto, FMCG, IT, media, metal, PSU banks, realty, and oil and gas indices ended in the red, while consumer durables, pharma, finance, and bank indices showed gains.



### World Bank Upgrades India's GDP **Growth Forecast to 7% for FY25**

The World Bank has revised India's GDP growth forecast to 7% for FY25, up from its earlier estimate of 6.6%. This upward revision is attributed to increased infrastructure investments and a rise in household investments in real estate. The bank also projects a growth rate of 6.7% for FY26. Despite this positive outlook, the report highlights persistent challenges, including high urban youth unemployment at

17% and a loss of market share in labor-intensive sectors like apparel and footwear.

India's economic growth reached 8.2% last fiscal year. However, industrial growth is expected to decelerate to 7.3% in FY26 from 7.6% in FY25, following a robust 9.5% recovery in FY24. The World Bank also anticipates a slowdown in Gross Fixed Capital Formation (GFCF), with growth projected to decrease to 7.8% in FY25 from 9.0% in FY24.

Service sector growth is projected to decline to 7.4% in FY25 and 7.1% in FY26, down from 7.6% in FY24. Conversely, agricultural growth is expected to surge to 4.1% in FY25 from 1.4% in FY24.



On the trade front, global protectionism and increased trade barriers are noted. Despite these challenges, India is enhancing its competitiveness through initiatives like the National Logistics Policy (NLP). Export growth is forecasted at 7.2% in FY25 and FY26, with a rise to 7.9% by FY27. Import growth is expected to slow to 4.1% in FY25 but will increase in subsequent years.

The World Bank report emphasizes opportunities for India to diversify its export portfolio beyond IT, business services, and pharmaceuticals. It also notes that India can improve its position in global value chains and boost trade-related job creation to counter the current account deficit, which is projected to widen in the coming years.

### Oil Prices Drop 2% Amid Demand **Concerns and Production Disruptions**

Oil prices fell by 2% on Tuesday as weaker economic growth in China, the world's largest crude importer, heightened demand worries. Brent crude futures dropped \$1.65, or 2.1%, to \$75.87 a barrel by 1004 GMT. Meanwhile, West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures, which had not settled on Monday due to the U.S. Labor Day holiday, decreased by \$1.06, or 1.4%, to \$72.49.

Charalampos Pissouros, a senior investment analyst at XM, attributed the decline to disappointing Chinese manufacturing data. "The weaker-than-expected Chinese manufacturing PMI over the weekend likely exacerbated con-

cerns about China's economic performance," Pissouros said. He noted that while disruptions in Libya and the Middle East are providing some support to prices, they are not enough to counterbalance the demand concerns.

China's economic data showed new export orders fell for the first time in eight months in July, and the pace of new home price increases in August slowed to its weakest of the year.

In Libya, oil exports were halted on Monday, and production was curtailed due to a political standoff over central bank control and oil revenues. The National Oil Corp (NOC) declared force majeure on its El Feel oilfield starting



September 2. Libya's production plummeted to around 591,000 barrels per day (bpd) as of August 28 from nearly 959,000 bpd on August 26. Production was about 1.28 million bpd on July

Despite these supply disruptions, limited upside support is expected due to uncertainty over the duration of outages. OPEC+ plans to increase output by 180,000 bpd in October, which could affect price trends. "It remains to be seen how low prices can go before OPEC+ reacts," said Panmure Liberum analyst Ashley Kelty.

Additionally, ongoing disruptions in the Middle East, including minor attacks on oil tankers in the Red Sea, are also influencing the market.

### Adani Green Energy and TotalEnergies Launch Solar JV for 1,150 MW Projects

Adani Green Energy Limited (AGEL) and TotalEnergies have announced a strategic joint venture (JV) to manage a portfolio of solar projects totaling 1,150 MW, located within the world's largest renewable energy plant in Khavda, Guja-

On September 3, AGEL's stock traded down 1.95% at ₹1,907.20 on the BSE.

Under the new agreement, AGEL will contribute its existing assets to the JV, while TotalEnergies will invest USD 444 million to expedite project

development. This partnership aims to accelerate India's transition to clean energy, leveraging AGEL's expertise in large-scale green energy projects. The electricity generated from these solar projects will be sold through Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) with the Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) and on the wholesale market.

AGEL is already leading the development of the Khavda renewable energy plant, which spans 538 square kilometers—five times larger than Paris. The site has thus far operationalized 2,250 MW of solar and wind energy capacity. Once completed, the plant is projected to provide clean energy to over 16 million homes, create more than 15,200 green jobs, and cut



CO2 emissions by around 58 million tons annually.

The JV's completion depends on regulatory approvals and other customary closing conditions.

In a related development, Adani Energy Solutions Ltd. (AESL) announced on September 2 that it has finalized the acquisition of the special purpose vehicle (SPV) for the Khavda Phase IV Part-A transmission project. This project, established by REC Power Development and Consultancy (RECPDCL), includes a transmission line to connect Khavda with Lakadia and Bhuj in Gujarat, featuring a transformation capacity of 4,500 MVA.



# Weaponised Drones Escalate Crisis in ManipurAmid ongoing Ethnic Violence

¬or the first time, the conflict-ridden state of Mani- The police's assertion that RPGs were fired from drones has pur witnessed the use of weaponised drones to drop bombs, marking a significant escalation in the ongoing ethnic violence between the Meitei community and the Kuki tribes. Until recently, drones were primarily used for personal purposes, such as capturing videos for social media. However, since the clashes began in May 2023, their role has dramatically shifted.

On Sunday, the Manipur Police reported that suspected Kuki insurgents employed high-tech drones to fire rocket-propelled grenades (RPGs) and drop explosives on security forces and civilians. This development has raised alarm among the authorities, as the use of drones for such purposes represents a new and dangerous dimension in the conflict.

The use of these drones became evident during an attack on Koutruk village, where a 31-year-old woman from the Meitei community was killed, and her 12-year-old daughter was among ten others injured. Most of the victims sustained shrapnel wounds from explosives dropped by the drones, according to sources. The police's claim that drones were used to fire RPGs has been met with skepticism, as experts suggest that while drones can be modified to drop bombs, firing RPGs would require a much larger, military-grade drone.

From Hobby to Warfare

Before the ethnic violence erupted in May 2023, drones were commonly used by residents of Manipur for recreational purposes, including capturing videos for social media. Both the Meitei and Kuki communities had vloggers with substantial followings on platforms like YouTube and Instagram. However, as tensions escalated, the use of drones shifted from a hobbyist tool to a weapon of war.

Since the clashes began, drones have frequently been spotted over villages near the foothills, where they have been used by both sides to monitor enemy positions and plan attacks or defenses. The appearance of drones over these areas signaled a shift in their usage, as they became tools for reconnaissance and tactical planning rather than social media content creation.


#### Open Display on Social Media

The growing use of drones in the conflict has also been reflected on social media, where both communities have

openly flaunted their drones. Licypriya Kangujam, a child climate activist from Manipur, faced allegations from the Kuki tribes of purchasing high-end thermal drones and donating them to the Meitei volunteer defense group, Arambai Tenggol. This accusation highlights the extent to which drones have become a symbol of power and influence in the ongoing conflict.

In June, Assam's Special Task Force (STF) arrested a man accused of sourcing drone parts for a terror group in Manipur's valley areas. The STF seized a significant stock of drone parts, marking what they called a "major breakthrough" in understanding the extent of drone usage in the region. Another arrest in the same month involved a man attempting to smuggle 10 high-end drone batteries into Manipur for a terror group. Despite claims that these batteries were intended for a filmmaker's association, the incident underscores the growing militarization of drone technology in the state.

#### Drones in the Regional Context



The use of weaponised drones in Manipur is not an isolated incident in the region. Just across the border in Myanmar, Chin insurgents have used drones to bomb targets belonging to the junta's army in Chin State. The ethnic ties between the Kuki tribes in Manipur and the Chin insurgents in Myanmar have led to allegations that the latter may be assisting the Kukis in their conflict with the Meitei community, although no concrete evidence has been provided by security forces.

The conflict in Manipur, which has claimed over 220 lives and displaced nearly 50,000 people, is rooted in deep-seated ethnic tensions. The general category Meiteis seek inclusion under the Scheduled Tribes category, while the Kuki tribes, who share ethnic ties with people in Myanmar's Chin State and Mizoram, demand a separate administration citing discrimination and unequal distribution of resources.

As the violence in Manipur continues to escalate, the introduction of weaponised drones into the conflict represents a dangerous turning point. The use of such technology not only intensifies the violence but also raises serious concerns about the future trajectory of the conflict and the potential for further escalation.

His strike rate of 136.12, though respectable, was scrutinized in comparison to other prominent players like Rohit Sharma, Virat Kohli, and younger stars such as Ruturaj Gaikwad and Sanju Samson.



Rahul also reflected on a difficult moment in his career back in 2019 when he and Hardik Pandya were suspended and fined for comments made during an appearance on the talk show "Koffee With Karan." Although the suspension was short-lived, it left a lasting impact on Rahul, who admitted that it was the first time he had ever faced such disciplinary action, even during his school days.

### Sumit Antil Wins Gold in Javelin Throw, Becomes First Indian Man to Defend Paralympics Title



to go to any extent to prove these allegations are baseless and will take all necessary steps to bring those responsible to light. Thank you for your concern. The rest will be handled legally."




