India Successfully Launches Agni 4 Ballistic Missile in Odisha Test Range



TPN, Odisha: India successfully launched the intermediate-range ballistic missile Agni 4 from the Integrated Test Range in Chandipur, Odisha, the Ministry of Defence confirmed on Friday. This latest test launch validates all technical and operational parameters of the missile, the ministry said.

The launch was conducted under the supervision of the Strategic Forces Command (SFC), which oversees India's missile and nuclear arsenal. The Agni 4 is part of India's robust missile program, developed to enhance its long-range, surface-to-surface, nuclear-capable ballistic missile capabilities.

In addition to this successful launch, India had earlier tested the new generation ballistic missile, Agni-Prime, on April 4 this year. That test was also carried out in collaboration between the SFC and the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).

India's Agni missile series has been a cornerstone of the country's strategic defence capabilities, playing a crucial role in maintaining a credible deterrent posture with its long-range nuclear strike capabilities.

Treat AP and Telangana Equally

CM Revanth Reddy Appeals to Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan

TPN, Telangana: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has made an earnest appeal to Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan to allocate adequate funds for immediate relief and permanent rehabilitation works in the wake of the recent floods in the state.

During a meeting at the Secretariat, the CM emphasized the need for

equal treatment for both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, urging the Union Minister to treat the two Telugu states as one when providing assistance.

Through a power point presentation, CM Revanth Reddy and his team briefed the Union Minister on the extent of the damage caused by the floods. The preliminary estimate

puts the total loss at Rs. 5,438 crore. Revanth Reddy requested that the guidelines regarding the release of National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF) funds be relaxed to expedite relief efforts in Telangana.

The Chief Minister highlighted that some districts in Telangana experienced over 40 cm of rainfall in a single day, leading to widespread

damage. Roads, houses, and bridges have been destroyed, and traffic has come to a halt in several flood-affected areas. CM Revanth Reddy also informed the Union Minister that the Telangana government is providing Rs. 10,000 as immediate financial assistance to affected families, but additional central support is critical for long-term recovery.

B. Mahesh Kumar Goud Appointed President of Telangana PCC



TPN, Telangana: The All India Congress Committee (AICC) has appointed Bomma Mahesh Kumar Goud as the new President of the Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (PCC). This announcement was made by AICC General Secretary KC Venugopal. The tenure of former PCC President, Revanth Reddy, ended on July 7, creating a vacancy for the leadership position.

Several senior Congress leaders vied for the post, including Campaign Committee Chairman Madhuyashki Goud, Government Whip Adluri Laxman, and Mahbubabad MP Balram Naik. However, the leadership ultimately selected Mahesh Kumar Goud to take on the role of Telangana PCC President.

This appointment comes as the Congress gears up for the upcoming state elections, with Mahesh Kumar Goud expected to lead the party's efforts in Telangana.

Bandi Sanjay: "Left Politics Aside to Address Flood Emergency"

TPN, Telangana: Union Minister of State Bandi Sanjay emphasized that people in the Telugu states are facing immense hardship due to the recent heavy rains and floods. Speaking to the media after attending a review meeting at the Secretariat, he stated that under these emergency conditions, he put politics aside to focus on relief efforts. Alongside Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, Bandi Sanjay participated in the review to assess the flood situation in the region.

Bandi Sanjay highlighted the extensive damage caused by the floods across Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. He assured that the central government would examine the flood damage reports submitted by both state governments and provide the necessary assistance. He emphasized that this is not a political issue but a humanitarian crisis, stating that it is everyone's responsibility to support people in their time of need.

Criticizing the previous government for not utilizing the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) amounting to Rs. 1,345 crores, Bandi Sanjay vowed to bring this issue to the attention of the Centre. He further added that Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has promised full support to the Telugu states in addressing the crisis.



KCR Navagraha Mahayagam - Target Fix..!!

TPN, Telangana: Former Chief Minister K Chandrababtu Naidu (KCR) did a Navagraha Mahayagam at his Erravelli farmhouse, seeking divine blessings through rituals performed with Vedic scholars. Alongside his wife Shobha, KCR is performing this special pooja as part of his preparations for a political comeback in Telangana.

During his tenure as CM, KCR frequently performed yagas, and following the recent political setbacks as losing the Assembly elections and the arrest of his daughter Kavitha—he has remained out of the public eye, focusing on personal matters. However, with Kavitha now out on bail in the Delhi liquor scam, KCR has called for a meeting with party leaders on the 11th of this month to strategize his return to active politics.

Sources suggest that KCR plans to focus on key issues like the farmer loan waiver, with district tours and agitation programs lined up to pressure the current government. His political revival efforts will likely take shape through district tours, starting on the 18th of this month, as part of his broader agenda to reconnect with the public.



Survey by Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chauhan in Khammam



TPN, Khammam: Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, along with Telangana Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka and Union Minister of State Bandi Sanjay, conducted an aerial survey of the flood-affected areas in Khammam district today. The survey covered the flood-hit regions of Khammam, Paleru, and Madhira, which were severely impacted by the overflowing of the Munneru river.

Khairatabad Vinayaka to Stand 70 Feet Tall This Year

TPN, Hyderabad: As the Vinayakachavithi festivals approach, devotees across the country and especially in the two Telugu states are preparing for the grand celebrations of Lord Ganesh. Among these, the Khairatabad Vinayaka in Hyderabad holds special significance. Known for its massive size and unique features, this iconic Ganesha idol draws thousands of devotees each year, and this time, it will stand an impressive 70 feet tall in honor of the 70th anniversary of the Khairatabad festivities.

This year, Khairatabad Vinayaka will take the form of the seven-faced Mahaganapati. On Thursday afternoon, sculptor Chinasmami Rajendran breathed life into the idol by fixing its eyes in a traditional ritual. The fully prepared seven-faced Mahaganapati idol was then consecrated during the Agaman program, which saw enthusiastic participation from local youth and devotees.

With Vinayakachavithi falling on a Saturday this year, and followed by a two-day holiday, authorities are expecting a larger-than-usual influx of devotees to the Khairatabad Ganapati. In anticipation of the crowds, the police have implemented comprehensive security measures, with officers set to perform duties in three shifts around the clock. Saifabad ACP R. Sanjay Kumar stated that the security detail would include three DSPs, 13 inspectors, 33 SIs, and 22 platoons of personnel.

In addition to the security arrangements, traffic restrictions have been imposed in the surrounding areas to ensure the smooth flow of devotees. The Vinayakachavithi celebrations will begin with a pooja performed by Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, with the Governor also expected to attend. The stage is set for what promises to be a grand and safe celebration of Lord Ganesh at Khairatabad this year.

Center Announces Rs 3,300 Crore Flood Aid for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana

TPN, New Delhi: The Central government has announced a generous flood relief package of Rs 3,300 crore for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, both of which have been severely affected by recent heavy rains and floods. The announcement comes as Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan is conducting an inspection of

the flood-affected areas in both Telugu states.

TPN, Hyderabad: The ongoing case involving Tollywood actor Raj Tarun and Lavanya has taken a new turn as the police have filed a chargesheet, officially naming Raj Tarun as an accused. This development comes after an investigation was launched following a complaint filed by Lavanya.

According to Lavanya's allegations, she and Raj Tarun had been in a cohabiting relationship for the past ten years. The police investigation has corroborated Lavanya's claims, with evidence confirming that the two had lived together in the same house. The chargesheet, backed by crucial evidence collected from Lavanya's residence, supports her accusations.

Raj Tarun, who has been involved in the case, has already secured anticipatory bail as the investigation progresses. The case has garnered significant attention, and further legal proceedings are expected to unfold as the police move forward with the charges.

Heavy Rain Alert Issued for Telangana

TPN, Telangana: The Meteorological Department has issued a fresh warning for heavy to very heavy rains in Telangana over the coming days. The Hyderabad Meteorological Department reported that a low-pressure system in the west and central northwest Bay of Bengal, as of 8:30 am on Friday, is expected to intensify. This depression is likely to develop into a cyclone by September 9 off the coast of Bangladesh.

The forecast indicates heavy rains in Telangana, particularly on Friday and Saturday. Districts such as Karimnagar, Peddapalli, Jayashankar Bhupalapalli, Mulugu, Warangal, and Hanmakonda are expected to witness significant rainfall, prompting the issuance of yellow warnings for these areas.

Furthermore, the department has predicted heavy to very heavy rains on September 9 and 10 in several parts of the state. On September 9, Komarambhim Asifabad, Manchiryal, Jayashankar Bhupalapalli, and Mulugu districts are expected to receive heavy rainfall, with orange alerts issued for these areas. Similarly, Adilabad, Karimnagar,



Peddapalli, Bhadradri Kothagudem, and Khammam districts are under yellow warnings for heavy rains.

On September 10, Adilabad, Komarambhim Asifabad, and Manchiryal districts are likely to experience heavy rainfall, leading to the issuance of orange alerts. Other districts such as Bhupalapalli, Nirmal, Nizamabad, Mulugu, and Bhadradri Kothagudem are also on alert for potential heavy rains, with yellow warnings in place.

The Meteorological Department has reassured that the cyclone threat has largely passed over the Telugu states, with the impact expected to be more severe in Odisha and West Bengal.

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Telangana Activist and BRS Leader Jitta Balakrishna Reddy Passes Away



TPN, Telangana: Telangana activist Jitta Balakrishna Reddy passed away on Friday while undergoing treatment at Yashoda Hospital in Hyderabad. He had been suffering from a brain-related illness for some time and had been receiving treatment for the past few days. Despite being on ventilator support, Jitta's health deteriorated, and he breathed his last on Friday. He is survived by his wife, daughter, and son.

The cremation will take place at his farmhouse on the outskirts of Bhuvanagiri town. His untimely death has shocked many, with Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, Union Minister Bandi Sanjay, Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka, BRS chief K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR), former ministers K.T. Rama Rao (KTR), and Harish Rao, among others, expressing their condolences.

CM Revanth Reddy said that Balakrishna Reddy's passing deeply saddened

him, describing him as a close friend who played an active role in uniting the youth during the Telangana movement. He praised Jitta as a leader of the movement who gained special recognition for his efforts. The Chief Minister expressed his deepest sympathy to Jitta's family members, praying for peace for his departed soul.

Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka also expressed his grief, stating that Balakrishna Reddy's untimely death was a great loss, extending his condolences to the family. BRS chief and former CM KCR mourned the loss, recalling Jitta's active participation in the Telangana Sadhana Struggle. KTR, Harish Rao, and other BRS leaders also conveyed their sympathies to Jitta's family.

Key Role in Telangana Movement

Jitta Balakrishna Reddy was a key figure in the Telangana movement, often raising his voice for public issues and play-

ing an active role in the fight for statehood. Despite contesting several times for the MLA position from the Bhuvanagiri assembly constituency, he remained steadfast in his commitment to the people, even when faced with defeat.

Known for his community service, Jitta organized various Telangana cultural events in Delhi, Hyderabad, and Bhuvanagiri. He was also a leader in environmental causes, leading a padayatra for the purification of the Moosi River and fasting for the foundation of the canal. Additionally, he established water plants in Bhuvanagiri and Aleru constituencies, using his own funds to benefit the local villages.

Jitta's dedication to the people of Telangana and his leadership during the statehood struggle have left a lasting impact on the community. His passing marks the end of an era for his supporters and the region he served so tirelessly.

BRS Leaders Visit Tribal Woman Assault Victim in Jainur, Demand Government Action

TPN, Komurambhim Asifabad: BRS leaders Harish Rao, Sunita Lakshmareddy, and Sabita Indra Reddy visited the tribal woman who was recently assaulted in Jainur Mandal of Komurambhim Asifabad district. The incident, involving an auto driver named Sheikh Magdoom attempting to sexually assault the woman, has sparked widespread outrage. During the visit, the victim's son explained the events, stating that his mother was on her way to tie a rakhi when the driver took her to a forest area and attacked her. Despite her resistance, the assault left her with injuries.

Former minister Harish Rao condemned the incident, calling it one of the worst in recent memory. He expressed concern over the rising number of such cases, noting that 1,900 rape cases were registered after Congress came to power. He highlighted that while BRS leadership, under KCR, maintained communal peace and order in Hyderabad, the current government's inaction is leading to an alarming increase in crime.

Rao criticized the government's lack of response, particularly in the case of the Jainur incident, and demanded swift action, including Rs.10 lakh in ex-gratia for



the victim. He also lamented the rise of religious sects and the breakdown of law and order, with the Dial 100 emergency response system reportedly not functioning.

Sunita Lakshmareddy echoed these concerns, expressing grief over the injuries visible on the victim and accusing the government of not taking the incident seriously. Sabitha Indra Reddy added that crimes against women have surged in the past eight months, creating fear for women's safety, even in Hyderabad. She stressed the need for immediate action to ensure the safety and security of women in the state.

BRS MLA Opposes Ordinance Merging ORR Villages with Municipalities

TPN, Telangana: BRS Quthbullapur MLA KP Vivekananda Goud has voiced strong objections to the Telangana government's recent ordinance that merges 51 villages around the Outer Ring Road (ORR) into nearby municipalities. He criticized the decision for being rushed and lacking prior consultation with local representatives.

Speaking at Telangana Bhavan, Vivekananda emphasized the absence of discussions with local MLAs and the failure to convene an all-party meeting on the ordinance. He expressed concern that the recommendations of the cabinet sub-committee were influenced by Congress leaders, without adequate representation from other political parties.

Vivekananda raised further concerns about the impact of merging these gram panchayats, arguing that

residents would be forced to pay taxes equivalent to those in Hyderabad without the necessary infrastructure in place to support such changes. He compared the development of other major cities like Delhi, Mumbai, and Chennai, which progressed through decentralization, warning that Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy's centralization plans could lead to challenges.

The MLA described the ordinance as a self-serving move that would place additional burdens on the public while providing little benefit. He highlighted Hyderabad's declining real estate market, attributing it to poor governance and unclear demolition guidelines. Urging the government to halt the merger, Vivekananda called for an all-party meeting to thoroughly discuss the matter.

AIMIM Delegation Meets Telangana DGP Over Asifabad Violence

TPN, Hyderabad: In the wake of violent attacks on Muslim properties and mosques in Jainoor, Kumaram Bheem Asifabad district, a delegation from the All India Majlis-e-Ittehadul Muslimeen (AIMIM) led by party floor leader Akbaruddin Owaisi met with Telangana Director General of Police (DGP) Dr. Jitender on Friday. The delegation demanded immediate action against those responsible for the arson and vandalism that followed the attempted rape of a tribal woman in the region.

AIMIM MLA Ahmed Bin Abdullah Balala, speaking to the media after the meeting, stated that the delegation provided the DGP with details of the attacks on 60 Muslim-owned shops and five mosques and requested stringent action against the perpetrators. Balala emphasized that while the individual who attempted to rape and murder the tribal woman should face severe punishment, those who instigated communal violence should also be held accountable.

Balala alleged that the violence appeared to be part of a premeditated conspiracy aimed at creating communal unrest in the state and instilling fear within the Muslim com-



munity. He called for strict measures to prevent such incidents from escalating in the future.

In response to the situation, Telangana DGP Dr. Jitender transferred Asifabad DSP Saidulu and replaced him with officer A. Karunakar to handle the situation more effectively. The district remains under heavy police presence, particularly in neighboring towns, to prevent further violence.

The unrest began on September 4, when a protest rally condemning the attempted rape led to a 5,000-strong mob attacking Muslim-owned shops and residential areas. The mob outnumbered local police forces, resulting in significant damage to Muslim properties before reinforcements arrived to restore order.

Kaynes unit: Contradictory versions of Industries Minister and Secretary

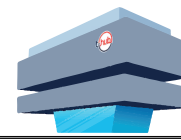


TPN, Telangana: There are conflicting accounts emerging from the Telangana Congress government regarding the status of the Kaynes Semicon unit's establishment in the state. While Industries Minister D Sridhar Babu assured that the company is committed to its Hyderabad project at Kongarkalan, Industries Secretary Jayesh Ranjan presented a contradictory version, confirming that Kaynes has shifted its focus to Gujarat.

On Tuesday, Minister Sridhar Babu emphasized that Kaynes Semicon remains fully dedicated to its advanced electronics manufacturing facility in Telangana, with the first phase already inaugurated. He added that the company's expansion in Gujarat would not affect its investments in Telangana, and the Kongarkalan plant is expected to employ 3,000 people.

However, Industries Secretary Jayesh Ranjan, in a YouTube interview, stated that Kaynes had indeed moved to Gujarat. He mentioned that the Central government encourages semiconductor companies to set up operations in Gujarat, which prompted the relocation.

The contrasting statements have fueled debate, with entrepreneur Nayini Anurag Reddy sharing the interview on social media, accusing Minister Sridhar Babu of trying to obscure the facts. Reddy highlighted that while clearances were provided for Kaynes' project in Telangana, the semiconductor unit has ultimately been relocated to Gujarat, raising concerns about transparency and political accountability within the state government.



Hyderabad Ice Cream Parlour Raided for Selling Whiskey-Infused Ice Cream to Children

TPN Hyderabad : On September 6, officials from the Prohibition and Excise Department conducted a raid at Ariko Cafe, an ice cream parlour located in Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad. The operation led to the seizure of 11.5 kilograms of ice cream suspected of containing whiskey.

The authorities discovered that the parlour had been infusing its ice cream with 100 pipers of whiskey, adding 60 milliliters of the alcohol per kilogram of ice cream. The illicit product was reportedly being sold at inflated prices.

In addition to the serious health and legal concerns, the Excise Department revealed that the shop had been promoting its whiskey-laced ice cream on Facebook to attract more customers.

This promotion exacerbated the issue, as it was targeted at a broader audience, including potentially underage individuals.

According to the Excise Department, the sale of alcohol-laced ice cream violates Section 34 A of the Excise Act. As a result, the authorities have filed charges against Dayakar Reddy and Shobhan, who are accused of manufacturing and selling the illegal product.

This raid underscores the department's commitment to enforcing alcohol regulations and protecting public health, particularly concerning products that may endanger children and other vulnerable groups.

Traffic Restrictions for Khairatabad Ganesh Festival

Para-Olympic Bronze Medalist Deepthi Jeevanji Receives Hero's Welcome in Hyderabad

TPN Hyderabad : Deepthi Jeevanji, the Para-Olympic bronze medalist from Telangana, was warmly welcomed by well-wishers and the sporting community at Hyderabad airport on Friday, September 6. The para-athlete, who hails from Warangal, Telangana, achieved third place in the women's 400 meters, T20 classification final at the Paris Para-Olympics on September 3, clinching India's second medal at the event.

Jeevanji, born in 2003, clocked 55.82 seconds in the 400-meter race, finishing behind Ukraine's Yulia Shuliar and Türkiye's Ayser Onder. Her impressive performance at the Stade de France in Paris marked a significant achievement for Indian para-athletics.

Born with an intellectual disability to daily wage laborers Jeevanji Yadhagiri and

Jeevanji Dhanalaxmi in Kalleda village, Warangal district, Deepthi faced numerous challenges on her path to success. Despite body-shaming and social exclusion from some villagers and relatives due to her cognitive disability, her physical education teacher recognized her potential for running. With support from renowned coach Pullela Gopichand, she transformed into an elite-level para-athlete.

Deepthi Jeevanji's journey to the podium is remarkable. Prior to her Para-Olympic success, she secured a gold medal in the 400 meters, T20 classification at the World Para Athletic Grand Prix in Morocco in September 2022, with a time of 57.66 seconds. She further distinguished herself by winning gold and setting a world record with a time of 55.06 seconds at the Para Athletic World



Championship in Kobe, Japan on May 20, 2024.

Her return to Hyderabad was celebrated by many, highlighting her resilience and dedication to her sport.

Telangana Health Minister Lays Foundation Stone for Osmania Medical College Girls' Hostel



TPN Hyderabad : On Friday, September 6, Telangana Health Minister Damodara Raja Narasimha laid the foundation stone for a new girls' hostel at Osmania Medical College. The project, valued at Rs 121 crore, aims to enhance the facilities for female students at the institution.

During the foundation ceremony, Raja Narasimha emphasized the importance of government hospitals matching the standards of private institutions. He stressed that the medical profession should be dedicated to serving humanity and acknowledged the esteemed reputation of Osmania Medical College as a key institution in Hyderabad.

The minister also highlighted recent achievements, including the clearance of long-awaited stipends for junior doctors by the Congress government. He addressed recent general transfers, noting that they were intended to bolster medical care in Telangana.

In addition to the hostel project, the health minister announced plans to lay the foundation for a new Osmania General Hospital at the Goshamahall police grounds within the next one to two months. The new hospital, to be constructed on 32 acres, will feature cutting-edge facilities designed to improve healthcare infrastructure in the region. Further enhancing the healthcare sector, the health and transport ministers issued appointment letters to 282 lab technicians. A notification for the recruitment of 1,284 additional personnel has already been released. Addressing the newly appointed technicians, Raja Narasimha emphasized their crucial role in managing critical reports and announced that the government plans to recruit 1,300 more technicians by next year.

GHMC Prepares 73 Immersion Ponds for Ganesh Festivities

TPN Hyderabad : In preparation for the Ganesh Chaturthi festivities, the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) has set up a total of 73 immersion ponds across the city. These ponds cater to various sizes of Ganesh idols, ensuring that the immersion process is smooth and organized.

The GHMC has established 27 baby ponds, 24 portable ponds, and 22 escalator ponds. These facilities are designed to accommodate a range of idol sizes, from small 2-foot idols to larger ones. Three Arrested in Hyderabad Ganja Raid; Two Women Still at Large

TPN Hyderabad : The Prohibition and Excise Department conducted a raid at a residence in Satyanarayana Nagar, Gudimalkapur, leading to the arrest of three individuals, including a man from Odisha. Officials seized 29.63 kilograms of ganja, two motorbikes, and three mobile phones during the operation.

The arrested individuals have been identified as Vishal Singh and Gopal Singh, both from Dhoolpet, and Santa Parida from Odisha. Additionally, two women—Sangeetha Sahoo

and Sheela Bai—are currently evading capture, according to the Prohibition and Excise Department. The department revealed that Sheela Bai was receiving ganja from Sangeetha Sahoo in Odisha and distributing it to local peddlers in Hyderabad. Recently, Sheela Bai obtained ganja through Santa Parida and, with Vishal Singh's assistance, was involved in its sale.

On Thursday night, the Prohibition and Excise team targeted Vishal Singh's residence in Karwan, Hyderabad. There, they apprehended

Gopal Singh and Santa Parida and confiscated the ganja and two motorcycles. The authorities are actively pursuing Sheela Bai and Sangeetha Sahoo, with efforts underway to bring them into custody.

This raid is part of a broader crackdown by the Telangana police on the illegal sale of ganja. The authorities have intensified their efforts to track down and apprehend drug dealers to combat the distribution of narcotics in the region.

AAP in 'Wait And Watch' Mode as Congress Debates Haryana Polls Alliance

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) has adopted a 'wait and watch' stance following disagreements with Congress over seat-sharing for the upcoming Haryana Assembly election. Sources revealed that discussions are currently on hold, pending decisions from AAP leader Arvind Kejriwal and the Congress' Central Election Committee, which is expected to meet soon.

Kejriwal, who had previously announced that AAP would contest all 90 seats in Haryana independently, is reportedly considering the alliance. However, his limited communication, due to his detention in Delhi's Tihar Jail over the alleged liquor excise policy case, has delayed further decisions. The Supreme Court has reserved its verdict on his bail plea.

Both parties, part of the INDIA bloc that united to contest the 2024 general election, had reached an 'in-principle' agreement on Wednesday after Congress leader Rahul Gandhi urged his party to proceed with the alliance, recognizing the need for cooperation to defeat the BJP, which has held power in Haryana since 2014.

Seat-Sharing Disagreements
AAP has requested 10 of Haryana's 90 Assembly seats, while Congress is only willing to offer seven, citing AAP's underperformance in the previous Lok Sabha election, where the party contested one seat and lost. In contrast, Congress won five of the nine seats it contested, preventing the BJP from achieving a clean sweep.

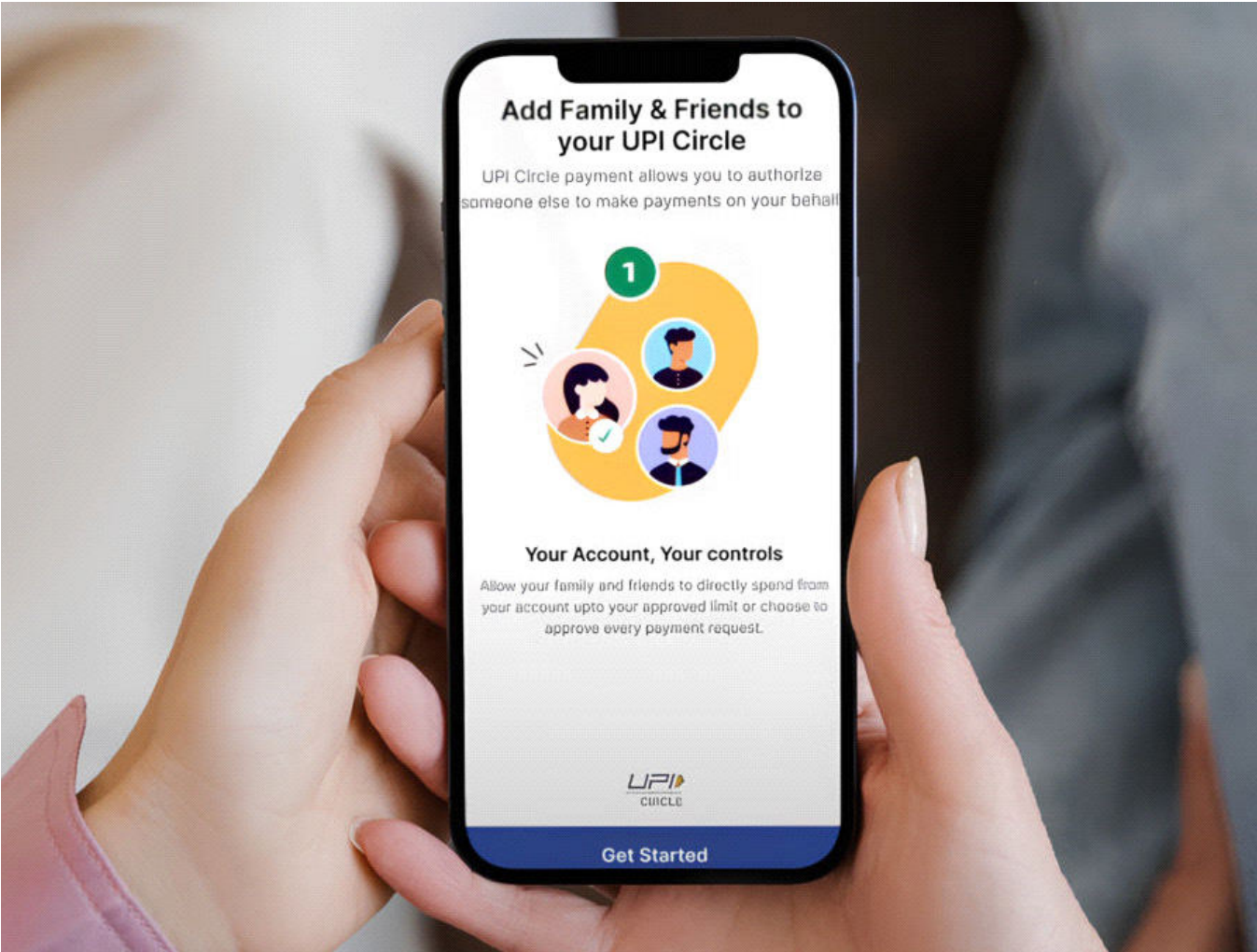
The seat-sharing discussions have been further complicated by the fact that AAP has requested seats within the constituency of former Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda, who was expecting to allocate these to his loyalists. Hooda has stated that the alliance was not state-specific and that discussions with AAP's state leaders have been limited since the general election.

Congress' Position Strengthened by Star Power
Congress' position in the seat-sharing talks may be bolstered by the addition of star athletes Vinesh Phogat and Bajrang Punia, who are expected to boost the party's appeal among Jat voters, a crucial demographic that accounts for 20 to 25 percent of Haryana's population.

BJP Faces Internal Challenges
The BJP, facing internal turmoil after releasing its initial list of 67 candidates, saw two key members – Jails Minister Ranjit Chautala and MLA Lakshman Napa – quit after being denied tickets. Chautala, the son of former Chief Minister Devi Lal Chaudhary, has announced plans to run as an independent candidate, while Napa has indicated that he will join Congress.

The BJP's list also included Sunil Sangwan, a former prison official who controversially granted parole multiple times to convicted rapist and Dera Sacha Sauda chief Ram Rahim.

Haryana Election Details
The Haryana Assembly election is scheduled for October 5, after being postponed from October 1 to accommodate the Bishnoi community's voting traditions. Results for the Haryana and Jammu and Kashmir elections will be announced on October 8. This will be the first election in Haryana since 2014, as political parties gear up for a fierce contest.



UPI Circle Launched: What Is It, How Does It Work, and Other Details

The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has introduced a new feature called "UPI Circle" aimed at enhancing accessibility to digital payments through the Unified Payments Interface (UPI). UPI Circle allows primary users to share their UPI account with family members or friends, who can then make transactions within predefined limits using the primary user's bank account. This feature is particularly designed for users who might not have their own bank accounts or are hesitant about using digital payments, empowering them with access to UPI transactions.

How UPI Circle Works

With UPI Circle, primary users can authorize secondary users, such as family members, friends, or employees, to make payments directly from their UPI account. The feature offers flexibility and control, as primary users can set transaction limits, monitor activity, and revoke access when needed.

Key Features of UPI Circle

- 1. Delegated Payments:** The primary user can add up to five secondary users who can transact using the primary account. This feature is useful for scenarios like parents providing allowances to children, senior citizens wary of digital payments, or business owners managing petty cash for staff.
- 2. Spending Limits:** The primary user can set specific spending limits for each secondary user. For example, a user can set different transaction limits for different people, all under the maximum limit of ₹ 15,000 per month, with no single transaction exceeding ₹ 5,000.
- 3. Approval Options:**
 - **Spend With Limits:** Secondary users can make payments within the pre-set limits without needing approval for each transaction.
 - **Approve Every Payment:** The primary user must approve each transaction, providing greater control over spending.

- their UPI app and revoke access at any time. For added security, secondary users will have a limit of ₹ 5,000 for the first 24 hours after being added.
- 5. Single Primary User:** Each secondary user can only be linked to one primary user, ensuring that their transactions are limited to one shared account.

How to Set Up UPI Circle

- 1. Access UPI Circle Menu:** Open your UPI app and select the "Add Family or Friends" option under the UPI Circle menu.
- 2. Add Secondary User:** You can add a secondary user by entering their UPI ID, scanning their UPI QR code, or searching for them in your phone contacts.
- 3. Set Permissions:** Choose between "Spend With Limits" or "Approve Every Payment" based on how much control you want to exercise.
- 4. Notification and Acceptance:** The secondary user will receive a notification to accept the request. Once accepted, they can start making payments using the primary user's UPI account.

Control and Flexibility

- **Add Up to Five Secondary Users:** Primary users can link up to five secondary users.
- **Revoke Access Anytime:** Primary users have full control and can revoke a secondary user's access at any time.

In A First In Three Decades, Woman Kashmiri Pandit To Contest J&K Assembly Polls

Jammu and Kashmir are set to witness a historic moment as a woman Kashmiri Pandit, Daisy Raina, prepares to contest the Assembly polls for the first time in three decades. Raina, a former private sector employee from Delhi and a sarpanch of Frisal village in Pulwama, is the lone candidate fielded by the Republican Party of India (Athawale), an ally of the BJP in the NDA alliance. She will contest from the Rajpora Assembly constituency in Pulwama, joining only nine other women in the electoral race.

Raina's decision to run for office stems from the encouragement she received from local youth, who wanted her to be their voice in the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly.

"The youth forced me to contest and asked me to ensure their voice reaches the Assembly," Raina told NDTV. She explained that the younger generation in Jammu and Kashmir, born in the 1990s, has been caught in the violence, only knowing a life of conflict and unrest.

Pulwama, a region known for its challenges, including the 2019 terror attack that killed 40 Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) personnel, has been a focal point of her campaign. However, Raina expressed that despite its troubled history, her work has continued successfully in the region. She highlighted the good relationships she has built with both the Hindu and Muslim communities during her tenure as



sarpanch, recalling how she had worked on projects benefiting both religious groups.

Having worked in New Delhi before being elected unopposed as a sarpanch in 2020, Raina is entering the election arena with a strong commitment to represent the underrepresented voices of the region, especially the youth.

The upcoming Jammu and Kashmir Assembly election will be its first in nearly a decade and its first since becoming a Union Territory following the abrogation of Article 370 in 2019. Voting will take place across 90 seats in three phases, from September 18 to October 1, with the results expected on October 8.

PM Modi Launches 'Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari' Initiative, Stresses Water Conservation

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday emphasized the importance of water conservation, calling it an integral part of India's cultural consciousness. Speaking virtually at the launch of the 'Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari' initiative in Surat, the PM advocated for the "reduce, reuse, recharge, and recycle" mantra to tackle the country's water challenges. The initiative aims to strengthen community participation in water conservation efforts. "For water conservation, we must adopt the mantra of 'reduce, reuse, recharge, and recycle'. Innovative techniques and the latest technology should also be embraced to ensure efficient water management," PM Modi said. He highlighted that India possesses only four per cent of the world's freshwater resources, with many regions facing severe water crises. Reflecting on the recent unprecedented rainfall and flooding across parts of India, the Prime Minister underscored the urgent need for water conservation, not only to safeguard water resources but also to manage natural disasters better. He added that water and environmental preservation have always been integral to India's cultural values. The 'Jal Sanchay Jan Bhagidari' initiative is closely aligned with the ongoing "Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain" campaign, which focuses on rainwater harvesting and sustainable water management practices. The initiative strengthens Modi's vision of a collaborative approach to water conservation, involving community participation to



ensure long-term water security. The Prime Minister urged citizens to make water conservation a collective effort, underscoring that only through active involvement can India achieve sustainable water management and overcome future challenges related to water scarcity.

Omar Abdullah Defends Seat-Sharing, Criticizes BJP's Article 370 Narrative

Former Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah has acknowledged that his National Conference (NC) "surrendered" seats to forge an alliance with the Congress for the upcoming Assembly elections. In an interview, Abdullah emphasized that having an alliance was "too important" to let a disagreement over a few seats jeopardize it. Initially, NC had prepared to contest all seats independently before the seat-sharing agreement. Abdullah also criticized the BJP's narrative around the abrogation of Article 370, arguing that its portrayal as a move welcomed by Jammu's residents was misleading. He pointed to the BJP's reduced margins in Jammu in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, compared to 2019, as evidence that support for Article 370's removal was not as widespread in the region as the BJP claimed. Additionally, Abdullah voiced concerns over the cancellation of the 149-year-old *Darbar move*, a tradition of shifting the government between Srinagar and Jammu. He argued that the move severely impacted Jammu's economy, which had benefited from government employees spending on local services during the winter months. As polling approaches, Abdullah avoided naming a chief ministerial candidate for the NC-Congress alliance, stating that his focus remains on winning as many seats as possible. The alliance will contest 83 of 90 seats, with NC taking 51 and Congress 32. Jammu and Kashmir's Assembly elections will be held in three phases, starting on September 18, with results to be declared on October 8.



Amit Shah Rules Out Restoration of Article 370 in J&K, Unveils BJP's Poll Manifesto



Unveiling the BJP's manifesto for the upcoming Jammu and Kashmir Assembly elections, Home Minister Amit Shah ruled out the restoration of Article 370, which granted special status to the region. Shah emphasized that the provision, abrogated in 2019, has "become history" and will not return. This comes as the National Conference, in alliance with the Congress, promised the restoration of Article 370 in its manifesto. During his two-day visit to Jammu and Kashmir, Shah stressed that the region is crucial to the BJP's vision of national unity and development. He highlighted the transformation from a period of separatism and terrorism, stating that the period from 2014 to 2024 will be remembered as a golden decade for Jammu and Kashmir. Shah criticized past governments for appeasing separatists and organizations like the Hurriyat, which he linked to the provision of Article 370. He credited the 2019 abrogation with fostering development in Jammu and Kashmir and accused the Congress of silently supporting the National Conference's push for reinstating Article 370. "Article 370 led to youth being handed guns and stones. Now it is part of the past, and it will never return," Shah said. Regarding the upcoming elections, Shah said the BJP's manifesto focuses on creating a "peaceful, safe, developed, and prosperous" Jammu and Kashmir. The Assembly elections, the first since 2014, will be held in three phases from September 18 to October 1, with results declared on October 8.

Wrestlers Vinesh Phogat and Bajrang Punia a Resign from Railways, Join Congress Before Haryana Polls

Wrestlers Vinesh Phogat and Bajrang Punia resigned from their posts with Northern Railways on Friday before joining the Congress party. However, their resignations have not yet been accepted, sources from the railways confirmed. The sources emphasized that until their resignations are approved, the wrestlers are prohibited from joining any political party or contesting elections under service rules. Phogat, who served as an officer on special duty (OSD) in sports with Northern Railways, shared her resignation letter on social media, expressing gratitude for her time with the Indian Railways. Punia also submitted his resignation on the same day.

BJP Accuses Mamata Banerjee's Government of Cover-up in Kolkata Doctor's Murder Case

The BJP has accused West Bengal's ruling Trinamool Congress (TMC) of covering up details in the rape and murder of a doctor at Kolkata's RG Kar Hospital in August. BJP spokesperson Sambit Patra flagged claims from the victim's parents, including allegations that a state official attempted to bribe them to hush up the case and that they were forced to wait for hours before seeing their daughter's body. The parents also claimed that after being informed of their daughter's death, police asked them to sign a blank paper, which they refused. The BJP has criticized Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and the Kolkata Police, suggesting mishandling of the investigation. In response, the TMC dismissed the claims, accusing the BJP of "vulture politics" and spreading conspiracy theories. A video has surfaced in which the parents initially deny any bribery attempt. However, a family relative alleged the video was filmed under pressure. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), which was tasked with probing the case, has nearly completed its investigation and ruled out gang rape. The CBI's findings align with Kolkata Police's earlier conclusion that Sanjay Roy, arrested last month, was the sole perpetrator. The TMC expressed satisfaction with the CBI's findings and demanded swift justice for the victim. The case has drawn intense scrutiny from the opposition, civil society, and the judiciary, with both the police and state government facing criticism for delays and alleged lapses.

Tensions Emerge in Maharashtra's Mahayuti Over 'Ladki Bahin Yojana'

Fissures have surfaced within Maharashtra's ruling Mahayuti alliance over the 'Ladki Bahin Yojana,' with Shiv Sena Minister Shambhuraj Desai accusing ally NCP and its leader Ajit Pawar of sidelining Chief Minister Eknath Shinde in the scheme's promotional materials. Desai expressed displeasure over Pawar's public outreach campaign, accusing him of "hijacking" the state government's 'Mukhyamantri Majhi Ladki Bahin' scheme, which provides ₹1,500 monthly financial assistance to eligible women. Desai emphasized that omitting the "Chief Minister" title from the scheme's name during Pawar's campaign events was inappropriate and not according to protocol. He stressed that the scheme was a state government initiative and Pawar should have included all stakeholders. Ajit Pawar, who is also the Deputy Chief Minister and Finance Minister, launched the NCP's 'Jan Sanman Yatra' last month, focusing on promoting the benefits of various government schemes, including 'Ladki Bahin.' However, the NCP's advertisements referred to the scheme simply as 'Majhi Ladki Bahin,' excluding the full name. Videos released by the NCP show beneficiaries thanking Ajit Pawar, further escalating tensions within the Mahayuti. The 'Ladki Bahin' scheme, modeled after Madhya Pradesh's 'Ladli Behana' initiative, was launched last month. CM Shinde has pledged to double the financial assistance under the scheme to ₹3,000 if the alliance is re-elected in the upcoming state elections, expected in November.

AAP-Congress Seat-Sharing Talks in Limbo Ahead of Haryana Election

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) has put its seat-sharing talks with the Congress on hold for the upcoming Haryana Assembly elections, sources revealed on Friday. The delay comes amid disagreements over the number of seats each party will contest, despite both being part of the INDIA alliance that performed well in recent general elections. AAP is waiting for a final decision from party chief Arvind Kejriwal, who is currently in judicial custody over the alleged liquor excise policy case. AAP is seeking to contest 10 of the 90 seats in Haryana, while Congress is reportedly offering only seven, citing AAP's poor performance in the Lok Sabha elections. The Congress, having onboarded prominent wrestlers Vinesh Phogat and Bajrang Punia, is using their appeal to strengthen its bargaining position, especially among the state's significant Jat population. Compounding the issues is AAP's desire to contest seats in regions dominated by former Chief Minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda, which he plans to allocate to his loyalists. With Congress leaders divided over conceding more seats to AAP, the seat-sharing agreement remains uncertain. Meanwhile, the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is also dealing with internal challenges after announcing its first list of 67 candidates. Notably, Jails Minister Ranjit Chautala resigned after being denied a ticket and plans to run as an independent. Haryana will vote on October 5, with results now scheduled for October 8, following a deferment by the Election Commission to accommodate the Bishnoi community's voting practices.

Despite Congress leader KC Venugopal's claim that Phogat received a show-cause notice after submitting her resignation, railway officials clarified that notices were issued earlier regarding the wrestlers' alleged political involvement, which violates service rules. Phogat, alongside Punia, played a central role in last year's protests against the former Wrestling Federation of India chief, Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, over allegations of sexual misconduct. Speaking at the press conference after joining Congress, Phogat praised the party for supporting their cause during difficult times. Sources suggest that at least one of the wrestlers may contest the upcoming Haryana Assembly elections on October 5.

India Becomes Key Player in Russia's Supply Chain Amid Western Sanctions



India Emerging as Crucial Supply Source for Russia Amid Sanctions

In a significant development, Russia is increasingly turning to India for sensitive goods and manufacturing capabilities as it grapples with extensive Western sanctions. According to the Financial Times, the Kremlin is not only seeking to source critical materials from India but is also exploring the possibility of relocating manufacturing operations there to ensure the stability of its supply chains.

The report highlights a dramatic rise in India's exports to Russia of dual-use technologies—items that can be used for both military and civilian purposes. Russia's Industry and Trade Ministry reportedly devised a plan in October 2022, aimed at investing over \$1 billion to secure these vital supplies through non-Western channels. This plan has prominently featured India as a key market for obtaining goods previously sourced from countries deemed "unfriendly."

India's growing role is underscored by its recent export surge to Russia, which saw a remarkable 40% increase in 2023, reaching \$4 billion. This boost has been driven largely by the export of electronic goods.

In addition to goods, Russia has leveraged the substantial reserves of Indian rupees accumulated from discounted fuel sales. The Financial Times also noted that an Indian firm, Innovio Ventures, supplied \$4.9 million worth of electronics, including drones, to Russia via Kyrgyzstan.

India's foreign minister, S. Jaishankar, defended the country's position on energy imports from Russia, attributing it to a strategic necessity rather than political maneuvering. He pointed out the tight global energy market and limited alternatives, emphasizing that India's oil strategy is driven by market dynamics rather than geopolitical considerations.

As Western sanctions continue to isolate Russia economically, India's growing role as a trading partner highlights shifting global economic alignments and the complex interplay of international trade politics.

Expert's August Prediction of Hamas Attack Proved Accurate as Conflict Escalates

On October 7, 2023, the Palestinian militant group Hamas, with backing from Iran, launched a severe and deadly invasion into southern Israel, marking one of the most devastating attacks in the country's recent history. The assault resulted in nearly 1,200 deaths and over 250 abductions, shocking Israel and the global community alike.

Remarkably, a forecast made by Yigal Carmon, a leading counter-terrorism expert and founder of the Middle East Media Research Institute (MEMRI), had predicted this violent escalation a month prior. Carmon's article, titled "Signs of Possible War in September-October," published on August 31, 2023, was one of the few early warnings that accurately identified the specific timeframe of the assault.

In his August analysis, Carmon highlighted the rising tensions on Israel's borders and the growing territorial demands from Hezbollah, along with the potential for an uncontrollable escalation. He noted that the deteriorating situation and the introduction of new, deadly weapons could trigger a large-scale conflict. His prediction was based on the increasing volatility and the risk of new weapons being used by militant groups.

Carmon's article specifically pointed to the Jewish holidays in September and October as a potential flashpoint, given the historical tendency for increased visits to the Al-Aqsa compound during this period. He warned that these factors could lead to a broader regional conflict, a scenario that tragically came to fruition.

In response to the Hamas attack, Israel launched a series of intense counter-offensive operations into Gaza, leading to the deaths of over 40,000 people, predominantly civilians. The conflict has resulted in a humanitarian crisis and has drawn widespread international condemnation.

Efforts to broker a ceasefire through meetings in Qatar have thus far been unsuccessful, with no tangible resolution achieved. As the region continues to grapple with the consequences of this brutal conflict, the world watches closely for any signs of a potential de-escalation or resolution.



Trump Announces Bold Plans for US Government Overhaul and Economic Reforms

In a recent address, former President Donald Trump outlined his ambitious plans for his potential second term in office, including the establishment of a task force led by Elon Musk. Speaking at the Economic Club of New York on September 5, Trump revealed his intentions to conduct a comprehensive financial and performance audit of the federal government.

Trump announced that the new task force, aimed at streamlining government operations and identifying areas for reform, will be headed by Elon Musk, CEO of SpaceX, Tesla, and X (formerly Twitter). According to Trump, Musk has agreed to lead this initiative, which he believes is crucial for enhancing government efficiency and cutting waste.

Trump praised Musk's expertise and endorsed his leadership in this significant role. The former president also detailed his broader economic agenda, which includes making the United States a global hub for cryptocurrency and bitcoin. He pledged to eliminate at least ten outdated regulations and introduce ten new ones to foster innovation. Additionally, Trump vowed to make his previous tax cuts permanent, with a specific focus on eliminating taxes on tips and social security benefits.

Addressing concerns over fraud and improper payments,



Trump claimed that such issues cost taxpayers hundreds of billions of dollars in 2022 alone. He promised that his proposed Government Efficiency Commission would devise an action plan to eradicate these problems within six months, potentially saving "trillions of dollars."

Further supporting American manufacturing, Trump proposed reducing the corporate tax rate from 21% to 15% for companies producing goods domestically. He also called for expanded research and development tax credits and increased bonus depreciation to stimulate domestic investment.

Bangladesh Urges Resolution of Teesta Water Sharing Dispute, Emphasizes International Norms

In a recent interview with PTI at his official residence in Dhaka, Bangladesh's Chief Adviser Muhammad Yunus underscored the urgency of resolving the long-standing Teesta water-sharing dispute with India. Yunus highlighted the need for adherence to international norms, emphasizing that lower riparian countries like Bangladesh have specific rights that must be respected.

"The delay in addressing this issue serves no purpose. Even if we are not entirely satisfied with the outcome, knowing our allocated share of water is crucial," Yunus said. He indicated that while the interim government is committed to pursuing a resolution, the process will involve collaborative discussions with India.

The Teesta water-sharing agreement, initially poised for signing during then-Prime Minister Manmohan Singh's visit to Dhaka in 2011, fell through due to opposition from West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, who cited water scarcity concerns in her state. Yunus noted that the issue has been a long-standing one, dating back to the era of Pakistan's rule, and stressed the need for a resolution.



Global 5G Handset Shipments Surge 20% in First Half of 2024

Global 5G handset shipments saw a notable 20% year-on-year increase in the first half of 2024, according to Counterpoint Research. Apple emerged as the dominant player in the market, capturing over 25% of the global share, driven by strong sales of the iPhone 15 and 14 series.

In a significant shift, India has surpassed the United States to become the world's second-largest 5G handset market, trailing only behind China. This surge is attributed to robust shipments from budget-friendly brands such as Xiaomi, Vivo, and Samsung.

Samsung secured the second spot globally with over 21% of the market share, bolstered by its Galaxy A and S24 series. Both Apple and Samsung featured prominently in the top-10 list of 5G models, with Apple holding the top four positions.

The Asia-Pacific region led the growth, accounting for 63% of global net additions and holding a 58% share of 5G shipments. The European, Middle Eastern, and African markets also experienced double-digit growth in 5G handset shipments.

Research Director Tarun Pathak noted that as 5G handsets become more accessible and network coverage expands, this upward trend is expected to continue, further driving adoption in emerging markets and beyond.





Market Crashes as Global Economic Fears Trigger Massive Sell-off: ₹5 Lakh Crore Wiped Out, PSU Banks and Oil Stocks Lead the Fall



The domestic stock markets trembled. Since morning, the sightings have been limited to the ground. International, European and Asian markets fell heavily due to US job data and expectations that the economy will be weak. This is the first time since August that the benchmark indices have crashed this badly. As BSE Sensex 1000 and NSE Nifty fell by 300 points, investors lost Rs.5 lakh crore of wealth. Especially PSU Bank shares fell. Oil and gas shares also saw selling pressure.

The BSE Sensex, which closed at 82,201 in the previous session, opened at 82,171 today. It touched an intraday low of 80,981. It touched an intraday high of 82,254. It eventually closed at 81,183, a loss of 1017 points. The NSE Nifty, which opened at 25,093 on Friday, touched a low of 24,801 and a high of 25,168. It finally closed down 292 points at 24,952. Bank Nifty fell 896 points to settle at 50,576.

In Nifty50, 8 companies gained while 42 lost. Shares of Bajaj Finance, Asian Paints, JSW Steel, LTI Mindtree and Nestle India were the top gainers. SBI, BPCL, ICICI Bank, NTPC and HCHL Tech were the biggest losers. Today, all the sector indices fell. PSU Bank, Oil and Gas, Private Bank, Media, IT, Auto and Finance in-

dices fell heavily.

Nifty support is at 24,900 and resistance is at 25,050.

In his address, Goyal also championed tourism, suggesting the establishment of a working

group focused on tourism collaboration with Mediterranean countries. He humorously referenced Mediterranean culture, noting his thoughts of “food and the movie *Mamma Mia*” when considering the region's potential for tourism growth.

Goyal underscored that India's economic progress hinges on several key factors: Make-in-India initiatives, digital transformation, innovation, and tourism. He pointed out that India boasts a large, aspirational population with an average age of 28.4 years, driving the country's dynamic growth and development.

India’s Forex Reserves Hit New High of \$683.99 Billion

India's foreign exchange reserves reached a record high of \$683.99 billion for the week ending August 30, as reported by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday. This represents a significant increase of \$2.299 billion from the previous week.



In the week prior, India's forex reserves had surged by \$7.023 billion, reaching \$681.688 billion. The latest data indicates that foreign currency assets, a major component of the reserves, rose by \$1.485 billion to \$599.037 billion. These assets reflect the impact of currency fluctuations, including the appreciation or depreciation of non-US currencies such as the euro, pound, and yen.

Gold reserves also saw a notable increase, growing by \$862 mil-

lion to \$61.859 billion. Additionally, the Special Drawing Rights (SDRs) component of the reserves rose by \$9 million, reaching \$18.468 billion.

This boost in India's forex reserves highlights the country's strong financial position and provides a buffer against global economic uncertainties. The increase in reserves is a positive indicator for the Indian economy, enhancing its capacity to manage external shocks and maintain economic stability.

Supreme Court to Fast-Track Appeal Against NCLAT Ruling on BYJU’s Insolvency

The Supreme Court agreed on Friday, September 6, to fast-track the appeal of US-based creditor Glas Trust Company LLC, challenging a National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) decision. The NCLAT had previously stayed insolvency proceedings against the ed-tech firm BYJU's and approved a Rs 158.9 crore settlement with the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI).

The bench, consisting of Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, Justice J.B. Pardiwala, and Justice Manoj Misra, was urged by senior advocate N.K. Kaul, representing BYJU's, to expedite the case. Kaul argued that the appeal was fundamentally flawed and needed swift resolution.

Chief Justice Chandrachud, recently recovered from quarantine, assured that the case would be listed for an early hearing. Senior advocate Kapil Sibal, representing Glas Trust Company, also requested an expedited review.

On August 22, the bench had previously declined to issue an interim order preventing the formation of a committee of creditors (CoC) as part of the insolvency process. The case was scheduled for a final hearing on August 27.

Earlier, on August 14, the Supreme Court had



stayed the NCLAT's August 2 verdict that had lifted insolvency proceedings against BYJU's and approved the settlement with the BCCI. The court had deemed the NCLAT's decision “unconscionable” and issued notices to the involved parties.

The dispute originated from BYJU's default on a Rs 158.9 crore payment related to a sponsorship deal with the BCCI. Following the initiation of insolvency proceedings, BYJU's reached a settlement with the BCCI. The Supreme Court directed the BCCI to place the Rs 158 crore received from BYJU's into a separate escrow account pending further orders.

The NCLT had earlier admitted BYJU's parent company, Think and Learn, to insolvency on July 16 due to the default. The NCLT's decision led to the suspension of BYJU's board and the appointment of an interim resolution professional. The US-based creditors questioned whether the settlement funds were being diverted from their credit.

Adani Group to Build Major Semiconductor Plant with Israeli Partner

The Adani Group, in collaboration with Israel's Tower Semiconductor Ltd, will establish a semiconductor fabrication plant aimed at enhancing India's chip-making capabilities. This development was reported by Bloomberg.

The plant, set to be constructed in Taloja, near Mumbai, will be a significant investment, amounting to ₹83,947 crore (approximately \$10 billion). Maharashtra's Deputy Chief Minister, Devendra Fadnavis, announced the project on social media platform X, highlighting its importance for the region.

According to Fadnavis, the plant will initially have a production capacity of 40,000 wafers per month, which will double to 80,000 wafers in the second phase. The facility is expected to create around 5,000 jobs, contributing to the local economy and advancing India's semicon-



ductor manufacturing sector.

The collaboration between Adani Group and Tower Semiconductor is seen as a major step in bolstering India's position in the global semiconductor industry. The new plant will not only help meet growing domestic demand for chips but also position India as a key player in the global supply chain for semiconductor components.

IMF Projects 6.8% Growth for India’s \$3.9 Trillion Economy in 2024

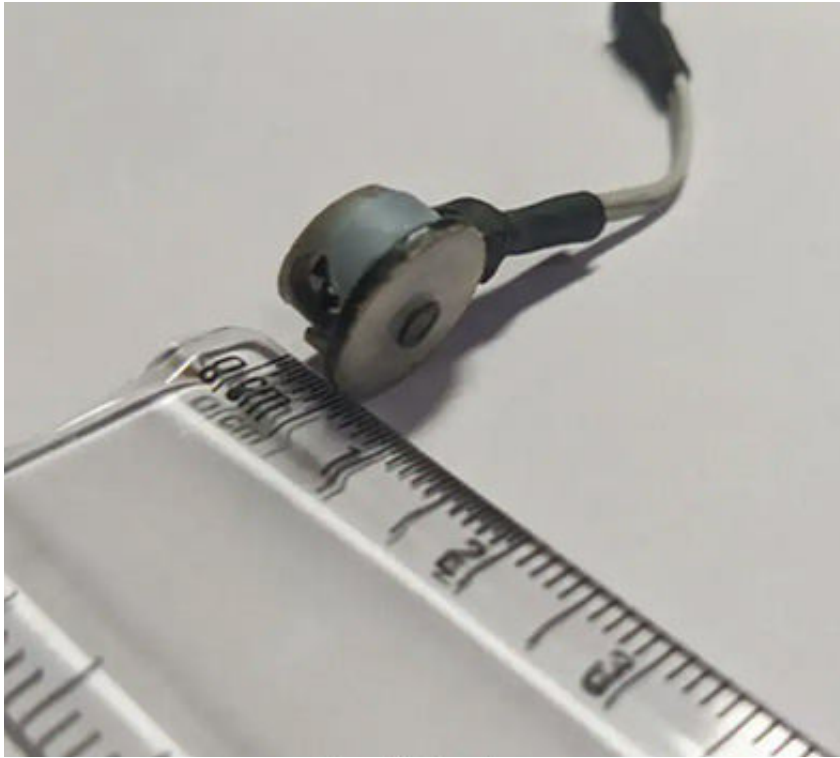

Indian Student Creates World’s Smallest Vacuum Cleaner



Tapala Nadamuni, an Indian college student, has set a new Guinness World Record for the world’s smallest vacuum cleaner. His innovative device, repurposed from a ballpoint pen, measures just 0.25 inches on its shortest axis.

Nadamuni invested approximately \$238 to transform the pen into a functional vacuum cleaner. The gadget employs a small revolving fan and a four-volt vibration motor to generate sufficient suction to pick up dust particles. This miniature marvel

showcases Nadamuni’s ingenuity and engineering skills.

This achievement marks Nadamuni’s return to the record books. In 2020, he previously held the record for the smallest vacuum cleaner with a device measuring 0.69 inches. However, his record was later surpassed by a competing gadget that was only 0.07 inches larger than his latest creation. Nadamuni’s persistent pursuit of innovation has now reclaimed his spot in the Guinness World Records.

New Mexico Sues Snapchat Over Child Exploitation Claims



On Thursday, New Mexico filed a lawsuit against Snap Inc., the parent company of Snapchat, accusing the platform of facilitating the sharing of child sexual exploitation material through its policies and design features. The lawsuit, led by Attorney General Raul Torrez, claims that Snapchat has become a primary venue for sextortion—a form of exploitation where predators coerce minors into sharing explicit content and then threaten to distribute it unless further content or money is provided.

According to the lawsuit, a months-long investigation revealed that Snapchat’s features, which include disappearing messages, have been exploited by predators to create and trade a “virtual yearbook” of child sexual images. Torrez criticized Snap for misleading users into believing that the disappearing nature of messages ensures privacy, while in reality, predators are able to capture and permanently store these images.

A Snap spokesperson stated that the company is reviewing the complaint and will address it in court. The spokesperson emphasized Snap’s commitment to online safety, noting that the company has invested hundreds of millions of dollars into its trust and safety teams and collaborates with law enforcement and online safety experts.

Snapchat is particularly popular among teens and young users, which raises concerns about the platform’s role in these exploitation cases. As part of its investigation, New Mexico’s Department of Justice created a decoy Snapchat account for a 14-year-old named Heather. This account reportedly engaged with other accounts bearing explicit names, including “child.rape.” Additionally, investigators discovered over 10,000 records related to Snap and child sexual abuse content on dark web sites, finding Snapchat to be a significant source of these materials.

OpenAI Surpasses 1 Million Paying Users

On Thursday, OpenAI announced a significant milestone, revealing it now has over 1 million paying users across its business products, including ChatGPT Enterprise, Team, and Edu. This marks a substantial increase from the 600,000 users reported in April, reflecting the success of CEO Sam Altman’s efforts to drive corporate adoption of ChatGPT.

The surge in paying users underscores the growing appeal of OpenAI’s advanced large language model, which continues to attract attention from businesses seeking sophisticated AI solutions.

In related news, The Information reported that OpenAI is considering higher-priced subscription options for its upcoming large language models, including “Strawberry,” which focuses on advanced reasoning capabilities, and a new flagship model named “Orion.” Internal discussions have explored subscription fees potentially reaching up to \$2,000 per month, according to sources familiar with the matter.



Currently, ChatGPT Plus is priced at \$20 per month, while the free tier is widely used by millions each month. OpenAI, supported by Microsoft, is also working on “Strawberry,” which aims to enhance AI models’ ability to conduct in-depth research through a specialized “post-training” process that refines the models’ performance beyond their initial training on generalized data.

The pricing discussions come amid reports that Apple and Nvidia are exploring investment opportunities in OpenAI, with a new fundraising round potentially valuing the company at over \$100 billion. This follows previous reports of significant interest from major tech players, further highlighting the rapid growth and high stakes in the AI sector.

China Firm Launches AI "Life Assistant" That Can Order Food

Ant Group, the fintech firm supported by Chinese e-commerce giant Alibaba, has expanded its portfolio with the introduction of a new artificial intelligence-driven mobile app named Zhixiaobao. Unveiled in Shanghai on Thursday, Zhixiaobao is designed to enhance daily life by offering a range of services including meal orders, taxi hailing, ticket bookings, and local dining and entertainment recommendations. The app also integrates with Ant Group’s existing digital payment platform, Alipay.

The launch aligns with the broader trend among tech giants like Google, Meta, and Microsoft, who are increasingly investing in AI technologies and integrating chatbots into their offerings. Cyril Han, president of Ant Group, emphasized the company’s commitment to leveraging AI to enrich user experiences, stating, “Alipay is committed to harnessing AI’s potential to improve the user experience, ensuring that AI assistants like Zhixiaobao become valuable tools in everyday life for all.”

Ant Group has faced significant challenges since its initial public offering was halted by Chinese regulators in 2020. The company has since restructured its business model to comply



with new financial regulations. In 2022, Ant was fined 7.1 billion yuan (approximately US\$984 million) for regulatory violations, following the departure of its founder, Jack Ma, from the company’s leadership.

The company’s financial performance has also been impacted, with profits falling 10 percent in the January-March quarter, and its valuation plummeting by over 70 percent since the failed IPO.

Zhixiaobao, described by Ant as an

“AI-native application powered by Ant Group’s Bailong foundation model,” signifies a step forward in the firm’s AI initiatives. The Bailong model, a large language model developed by Ant, received regulatory approval last year, allowing the company to introduce AI-driven products.

In addition to the consumer app, Ant Group also unveiled new AI-powered solutions aimed at merchants, health-care providers, and insurance sectors.

Mouldy Burger Sparks Outcry: Burger King and Zomato Respond

Food safety is a critical issue in India, as recent reports of contaminated and spoiled food highlight. A recent incident has further underscored this concern. Yaman Dev Sharma, a customer who ordered a Veg Whopper and fries from Burger King through Zomato, discovered mould on his burger. Frustrated, Sharma took to social media to express his disappointment and seek resolution.

In a video shared on X (formerly Twitter), Sharma showcased the mouldy burger, clearly visible on one side of the half-eaten bun. His post quickly gained traction online, drawing responses from both Burger King and Zomato.

Zomato was prompt in addressing the issue, stating, “This is very

shocking. We are sorry you had to experience this. We will investigate the matter. Meanwhile, a member of our team will definitely reach out to you. Please DM us your registered contact number.”

Burger King also responded, expressing regret over the incident. The company wrote, “Hi Yaman, we never intend to provide such an experience. Can you please DM us your Contact Number, Store Location, Order ID, and Email ID so that we can get in touch with you? Rest assured we will investigate this thoroughly.”

Both companies have promised to look into the matter and resolve the issue, highlighting the ongoing importance of food safety and customer satisfaction in the service industry.





Tokyo Silver Medalist Praveen Kumar Breaks Asian Record, Wins Gold at Paris Paralympics

Tokyo silver medalist Praveen Kumar delivered an exceptional performance at the Paris Paralympics 2024, clinching the gold medal in the men's high jump T64 event. The 21-year-old para-athlete set a new Asian record with a season-best jump of 2.08 meters on Friday. Kumar's achievement not only secured him the top spot but also contributed to India's record-setting six gold medals in this edition of the Paralympics, surpassing their previous best of five golds from the Tokyo Paralympics.

Kumar, who began his competition at a height of

1.89 meters, successfully cleared seven jumps on his first attempt, establishing a strong lead. The bar was then raised to 2.10 meters, where both Kumar and USA's Derek Loccident competed fiercely for the top position but ultimately could not clear the new height.

This victory marked Kumar's personal best performance and showcased his exceptional skills in the T64 category, which includes athletes with moderate movement impairment in one lower leg or those missing one or both legs below the knee. Kumar's

impairment, which affects the bones connecting his hip to his left leg, is congenital.

Kumar's journey to becoming a para-athlete was fraught with challenges. As a child, he struggled with feelings of inadequacy compared to his peers. Initially drawn to volleyball to combat these insecurities, his perspective shifted dramatically after participating in a high jump event at an able-bodied athletics competition. This experience revealed the extensive opportunities available for athletes with disabilities, redirecting his path towards para-athletics.

Neeraj Chopra Qualifies for Diamond League Finale

India's javelin throw sensation Neeraj Chopra has secured his place in the season finale of the Diamond League, thanks to a strong performance throughout the series. Chopra, a two-time Olympic medalist, finished fourth in the overall standings after 14 global meetings, earning him a spot in the finale scheduled for September 14-15 in Brussels.

Chopra accumulated 14 points from two second-place finishes in Doha and Lausanne. He opted to skip the final series event in Zurich on Thursday. The 26-year-old Indian athlete is just two points behind Czechia's Jakub Vadlech, with Grenada's Anderson Peters and German star Julian Weber leading the standings with 29 and 21 points, respectively. Peters clinched victory over Weber in the Zurich meet.

Chopra, who won gold at the Tokyo Olympics in 2021 and silver at the Paris Games last month, has been battling fitness issues this season. A persistent groin injury has hindered his performance and his pursuit



of a 90m throw. Despite these challenges, Chopra remains focused on recovery and improvement.

In Lausanne, Chopra finished second behind Peters, who achieved a throw of 90.61m. At the Paris Olympics, Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem won gold with a remarkable throw of 92.97m.

Chopra has set clear goals for himself, stating his intention to fully recover from his injury and enhance

his technical skills to achieve greater distances. Last year, he won the Lausanne Diamond League legs in both 2022 and 2023 and was the runner-up to Vadlech in the Eugene finale.

The Diamond League season finale not only awards the champion a prestigious "Diamond Trophy" and USD 30,000 in prize money but also a wild card entry for the World Athletics Championships. The Brussels event will conclude Chopra's season.

Jessica Pegula Remarkable Comeback to Reach First Grand Slam Final



Jessica Pegula staged a stunning comeback from a set and a break down to defeat Karolina Muchova 1-6, 6-4, 6-2 and secure her place in her first Grand Slam final at the US Open on Thursday. The sixth-ranked American will face world number two and Australian Open champion Aryna Sabalenka in Saturday's championship match. Sabalenka reached her second consecutive US Open final by defeating Emma Navarro 6-3, 7-6 (7/2).

Pegula admitted after the match that she felt fortunate to still be in contention. "She made me look like a beginner; she was destroying me and I was about to burst into tears," Pegula said. "But it all came down to small moments. I don't know how I turned that around."

Pegula has been in exceptional form, winning 15 of her last 16 matches on the US summer hard court swing, including a title in Toronto and a final appearance in Cincinnati against Sabalenka. "It's a chance for revenge, but she'll be tough to beat," Pegula noted.



Former India Coach Vikram Rathour Joins New Zealand Staff for Test Match

Vikram Rathour, the former India batting coach, has been appointed to New Zealand's coaching staff for their upcoming one-off Test against Afghanistan, set to begin on Monday at the Greater Noida Sports Complex. Rathour, who had a brief international playing career and served as a key figure in India's coaching setup, brings a wealth of experience to the New Zealand team.

Rathour played six Test matches for India in the late 1990s. After retiring from playing, he became a selector for the Indian national team in 2012. His most recent role was as the batting coach for India, where he worked under head

coach Rahul Dravid. During his tenure, Rathour played a significant role in shaping India's formidable batting line-up, contributing to their victory in the 2024 T20 World Cup.

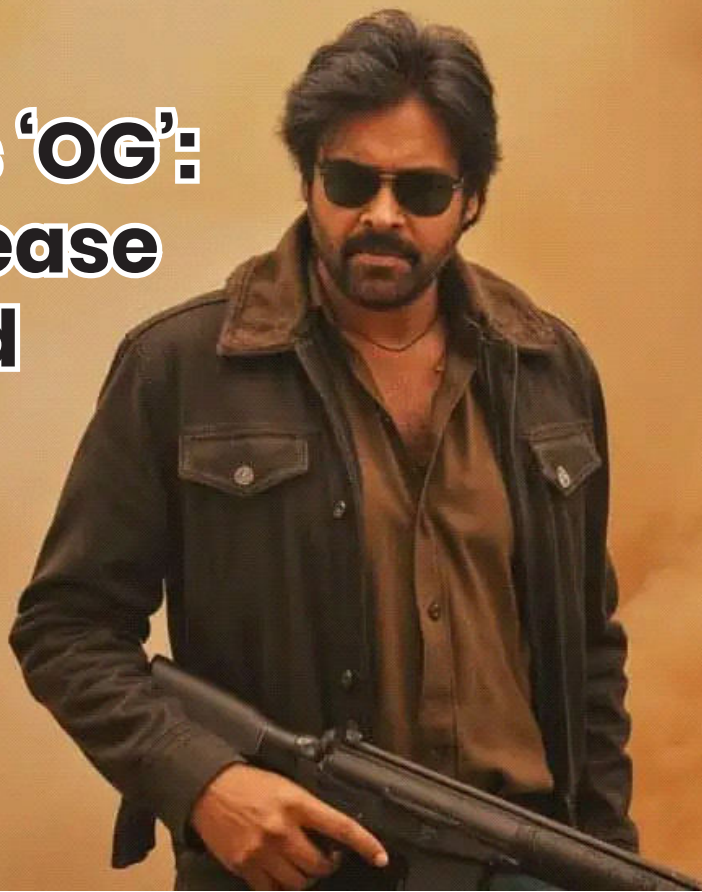
making headlines with his exceptional form, including two centuries in the second Test against Sri Lanka.
