TPN, Hyderabad: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy made notable remarks during a house plot distribution program for journalists, held at Ravindra Bharati in Hyderabad. Speaking at the event, where he served as the chief guest, CM Revanth Reddy stressed the importance of respecting the position of Chief Minister, regardless of personal opinions about the individual holding the office.

"You may not like me as a person. But Revanth Reddy is the Chief Minister of Telangana State. Chief Minister is an honorable position. You

may or may not like the person who holds that position. All the people have given that position together. Shouldn't the press and political party leaders under the guise of press owners have the responsibility to respect that position? When they don't comply, my question is why should we comply?" CM Revanth Reddy remarked, urging the media and political figures to respect the office of the Chief Minister.

During the program, Revanth Reddy distributed house allotment documents to journalists who are members of the Jawaharlal Nehru

Journalist Housing Society. He acknowledged the longstanding demands of journalists for housing, and while expressing regret that 73 journalists passed away before receiving their promised homes, he reaffirmed the Congress government's commitment to their welfare.

CM Revanth Reddy further assured that his government will provide accreditation cards, house plots, and health cards to eligible journalists. He promised that every eligible journalist will be allotted a house in Future City, ensuring that justice is delivered to all those who qualify.

Hydra Commissioner Ranganath Clarifies Stance on Demolitions



TPN, Hyderabad: The Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Protection Agency (Hydra) has taken decisive steps to address illegal constructions across the city, particularly those encroaching on ponds, lakes, and canals. Amid ongoing demolition drives, Hydra Commissioner AV Ranganath has provided clarification regarding the agency's approach to demolishing illegal structures.

In a public statement, Commissioner

Ranganath also highlighted recent actions taken in areas such as Mallampeta pond, where under-construction buildings in the buffer zone were demolished due to the lack of permits. He further noted that some commercial sheds built in the lime pond area had previously been demolished and were taken down again after reconstruction attempts. Criminal cases have been filed against builder Vijayalakshmi and former MLA Katasani Bhupal Reddy for their involvement in illegal constructions.

Reassuring citizens, Commissioner Ranganath made it clear that no occupied houses would face demolition. He urged the public to avoid purchasing plots and houses in FTL and buffer zones to prevent future issues. Despite these reassurances, Hydra's demolition activities continue across Hyderabad, with recent actions including the demolition of a three-storied house, a five-storied building, and several other illegal structures, including sheds, huts, and a hotel, in the Madapur lime pond FTL area.

Hydra's efforts highlight the ongoing battle against illegal encroachments in the city as the agency aims to preserve Hyderabad's water bodies and maintain legal land usage.

**In the name of Praja Govt...
They are demolishing
poor houses: KTR**

TPN, Hyderabad: BRS Party Working President K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) launched a sharp criticism against the Congress government, accusing it of demolishing the homes of the poor under the pretext of the "Praja Government" (People's Government). KTR took to social media to express his outrage, stating that the Congress administration, led by CM Revanth Reddy, is targeting vulnerable communities and dismantling their homes without consideration.

"In the name of the 'Praja Government,' they are mercilessly demolishing the homes of the poor," KTR said, referring to the ongoing Hydra demolitions affecting many low-income families in Hyderabad. He highlighted that the actions target numerous families and causing

KTR pointed out that, during the BRS regime, 40,000 double-bedroom houses were constructed and are ready for distribution to the poor in Hyderabad. He urged the Telangana Chief Secretary to allocate these houses to those in need as soon as possible to alleviate their suffering.

KTR further called for decisions on resettlement to be made with a humanitarian perspective, ensuring equal justice for all affected people. The ongoing demolitions have sparked political debate in the state, as KTR continues to push for solutions that prioritize the well-being of the poor.



Union Minister Kishan Reddy Visits Flood-Affected Areas in Khammam

TPN, Khammam: Khammam district has been severely impacted by recent heavy rains, resulting in both loss of life and significant property damage. In response, CM Revanth Reddy and state ministers have been visiting the flood-affected areas to assess the situation. Recently, Union Minister Kishan Reddy toured the hardest-hit areas of Khammam district, including Damsalapuram, Thirumalayapalem, and Rakasi Thanda in the 16th Division of Khammam city.

During his visit, Kishan Reddy interacted with flood victims, listening to their concerns and distributing essential supplies. He was accompanied by State Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy, MPs Visveshwar Reddy, and Etala Rajender. This follows a visit by Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, who met with CM Revanth Reddy to discuss the flood damage and assured support from the Centre.

Meanwhile, Khammam district continues to face heavy rainfall, with Warangal and Mahabubabad also receiving heavy downpours. The increasing floodwaters in Bayyaram and Garla ponds have raised concerns of potential flooding in Munneru and Akeru. As a precaution, the district collector has ordered road closures towards Munneru.

Residents from Danwaigudem, Ramanapet, Prakash Nagar, Motinagar, and Venkateswara Nagar, who live near Munneru, have been advised to relocate to government-run resettlement centers. Khammam District Collector Muzamil Khan, alongside CP Sunil Dutt, inspected the Deputy CM Bhatti Vikramarka Rehabilitation Centre. Authorities have been directed by state ministers to evacuate people from vulnerable areas, particularly around Tummala and Ponguleti, to ensure their safety.



Paralympic Bronze Medalist Deepti Honored by CM Revanth Reddy



TPN, Hyderabad: Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy honored Paralympics 2024 bronze medalist Deepti Jeevanji at a special felicitation event held at his residence in Jubilee Hills on Saturday. The CM awarded Deepti a cash prize of one crore rupees and 500 yards of land in Warangal as a token of appreciation for her remarkable achievement. Additionally, the CM announced that Deepti would be offered a Group-2 level government job. Her coach, Nagpuri Ramesh, was also recognized with a cash reward of Rs. 10 lakhs for his contribution to Deepti's success.

The CM praised Deepti for proving that "disability is not an obstacle to achieving goals" and reaffirmed the state government's commitment to supporting sports and athletes. He instructed officials to ensure proper training and incentives for athletes competing in the Paralympics, underscoring the government's priority on promoting sports.

Deepti, who hails from Kalleda village in Parvatgiri mandal of Warangal district, won the bronze medal in the women's 400m T20 final at the 2024 Paralympics in Paris. Her journey to success is a testament to her hard work and determination. Her parents, Yadagiri and Lakshmi, played a pivotal role in supporting her, despite the challenges posed by her disability. Yadagiri even contemplated selling his one-acre farm to fund Deepti's participation in sports competitions.

Deepti's victory has inspired her local community, and her story serves as a powerful example of resilience and perseverance.

Telangana floods Health min asks officials to maintain power supply, sanitation

TPN, Telangana: In light of the recent floods that struck Telangana and with more heavy rains forecasted, Telangana Medical, Health, and Family Welfare Minister Damodar Rajanarsimha held a critical meeting on Sunday, September 8, to review the medical situation in the flood-affected districts of Khammam, Bhadradri Kothagudem, Mahabubabad, Mulugu, and Suryapet.

During the meeting, the health minister focused on the availability of essential medicines and the operational status of medical facilities in these regions. He also stressed the importance of safeguarding the health of pregnant women expected to deliver within the next 15 days, instructing officials to ensure their care amidst challenging conditions.

A key priority discussed was maintaining an uninterrupted power supply to hospitals

to prevent disruptions in medical services. The minister also evaluated the availability of emergency vehicles and reviewed the sanitation efforts, particularly in high-risk flood-affected areas. He called for effective coordination between health officials and the Panchayat Raj and municipal departments to ensure smooth operations.

In a teleconference with district collectors and medical officials, Rajanarsimha emphasized the urgency of ensuring continuous medical services in flood-impacted regions. He directed immediate action to prevent the spread of vector-borne diseases by ramping up fogging efforts and mosquito prevention measures.

The health minister's proactive approach aims to mitigate the health risks posed by the floods and ensure the well-being of vulnerable populations, particularly pregnant women, across the state.

Telangana Rains Heavy Rainfall Expected in Several Districts

TPN, Telangana: The Hyderabad Meteorological Department (IMD) has forecast heavy rainfall across several districts in Telangana over the next two days. An orange alert has been issued for multiple districts, signaling the potential for significant rainfall on Tuesday, while a yellow alert has been issued for Wednesday. Hyderabad is also expected to experience light to moderate rains over the next three days.

In the last 24 hours, Mahabubabad district recorded 18 cm of rain, Khammam 12 cm, and Ranga Reddy 11 cm. Shakepet in Hyderabad saw the highest rainfall in the city with 63 mm. The IMD has warned of heavy rains across the state for the next three days, with strong surface winds anticipated in certain regions.

Districts under orange alert include Kumaram Bheem Asifabad, Mancherial, Jayashankar Bhupalapally, Mulugu, and

Bhadradri Kothagudem, where heavy rains and strong winds are expected on Sunday and Monday. Several districts, including Kumuram Bheem Asifabad, Jayashankar Bhupalapalli, Mulugu, Bhadradri-Kothagudem, Mahabubabad, Warangal, Suryapet, Khammam, Janagam, Nizamabad, Kamareddy, Medak, and Sangareddy, are predicted to experience light to very heavy rainfall.

The Telangana Development Planning Society (TGDPs) has forecast that the intensity of the rains may decrease by September 10. However, light to moderate rains or thundershowers are expected in all mandals of Hyderabad district through September 11, according to the IMD.

Residents in affected areas are advised to stay informed and take necessary precautions as the state continues to experience unpredictable weather conditions.

Murali Mohan Responds to Hydra Notices, Promises to Remove Shed



TPN, Hyderabad: Senior actor and businessman Murali Mohan has addressed the Hydra notices received by Jayabheri's organization, confirming the validity of the notices. The issue revolves around a temporary shed in the buffer zone of Rangalalkunta pond in Gachibowli. Murali Mohan clarified that Jayabheri has never committed any encroachments and that the shed had unintentionally extended three feet into the buffer zone.

Responding to complaints from local residents, Hydra officials inspected the site and found the violation. Although Hydra gave Jayabheri 15 days to remove the shed, warning that they would take action if the organization did not comply, Murali Mohan assured that the shed would be removed by Tuesday evening.

Murali Mohan emphasized that there was no need for Hydra to intervene, as Jayabheri would handle the demolition on its own. He reiterated that in his 33 years in the real estate sector, he has never been involved in any illegal activities.

Basara RGUKT Student Protest Hits Fifth Day



The student protest at Basara RGUKT (Rajiv Gandhi University of Knowledge Technologies) has now reached its fifth day. Students have been rallying from the administrative building to the main gate, holding placards and demanding immediate action from the government. Despite their prolonged efforts, there has been no substantial response from the authorities.

The protesters have outlined 17 key demands, including the appointment of a full-time Vice Chancellor (VC), increased transparency in funding, improvements to mess contracts and health services, better staff appointments, a review of food court tenders, and enhanced internet infrastructure.

Former minister and BRS MLA Harish Rao has criticized the Congress-led Telangana government for its handling of the situation. He accused the current administration of corruption and ineffectiveness, stating that the government's failure to address these issues has forced students to take drastic measures to get their voices heard.

Harish Rao addressed Congress lead-

er and Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, recalling Reddy's previous promises made during his time in opposition. "Revanth Reddy, you campaigned vigorously and made grand promises about solving Triple IT problems once in power. Now that you are the Chief Minister, instead of addressing these issues, you are failing the students," Rao said. He further criticized the Congress manifesto's promise to establish four new Triple ITs in the state, noting that no progress has been made.

Rao also highlighted broader issues within the education sector under the Congress government, including the closure of 1,800 schools, an increase in food poisoning cases, and the hospitalization of 600 students, with 40 reported deaths due to contaminated food. He called for a comprehensive state-level review of the education system and urgent measures to resolve the issues faced by Basara RGUKT students.

The BRS party continues to demand immediate action to address both the specific concerns at Basara RGUKT and the broader problems within the state's education system.

Telangana Govt Sends Essential Relief Material for Flood-Affected Khammam District

TPN, Telangana: In a coordinated effort to provide relief to the flood-affected victims of Khammam district, Telangana IT Minister D. Sridhar Babu flagged off essential relief materials at the Secretariat on Sunday, September 8. The initiative, conducted in collaboration with the Hyderabad Software Enterprises Associations (HYSEA) and other voluntary organizations, aims to support those impacted by the recent heavy rains.

Addressing the media, Minister Babu assured that the government is taking all necessary measures to assist the flood victims in Khammam district. He praised the involvement of voluntary organizations like HYSEA, which played a crucial role in organizing and delivering relief materials. A total of 10,000 relief kits, each valued at Rs 3,000, have been prepared for distribution to the affected communities.

State Agriculture Minister Tunmala Nageswar Rao was



also present at the event. Both ministers expressed their gratitude towards HYSEA and other organizations for stepping forward to help the flood victims during this challenging time.

Harish Rao Criticizes Congress Government Over Crop Loan Waiver Failures

TPN, Telangana: Former Minister and senior BRS MLA T. Harish Rao has sharply criticized the Congress government led by Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy for its mishandling of the crop loan waiver program, attributing the plight of farmers to bureaucratic inefficiencies and partial implementation. According to Rao, the government's failure to fully implement the waiver has resulted in the tragic suicides of 475 farmers over the past nine months.

Speaking at Telangana Bhavan, Rao accused Reddy of repeatedly setting and missing deadlines for the waiver while simultaneously neglecting the Rythu Bharosa investment support for the ongoing Vaanakalam (Kharif) season. Despite Reddy's promises to waive all crop loans up to Rs 2 lakh, Rao claimed the scheme was marred by numerous excuses and partial

rollouts, leading to widespread denial of benefits.

Rao highlighted the case of Surender Reddy, a farmer who took his own life in front of the Agriculture department office in Medchal. In his suicide note, Surender Reddy cited the denial of the loan waiver due to administrative complications involving his ration card. Rao criticized the government for creating unnecessary hurdles, such as requiring farmers to repay amounts exceeding the Rs 2 lakh waiver limit, and for failing to address these issues effectively.

The former Minister also condemned the Congress government for reducing the allocation for the loan waiver from Rs 49,000 crore to Rs 26,000 crore in the state budget, with only about Rs 17,000 crore spent so far. Rao noted that only 20 lakh farmers had

benefited from the waiver while 21-22 lakh were left out due to bureaucratic barriers, including issues as minor as missing Aadhaar cards for deceased family members.

Rao demanded an apology from Chief Minister Revanth Reddy and called for the immediate waiver of all outstanding crop loans. He emphasized that the BRS would persist in advocating for farmers' rights and would escalate the issue to the Governor and the Centre. The BRS grievance cell, he added, had received over 1.32 lakh complaints from farmers, and these issues would be formally presented to the Governor for resolution.

Rao concluded by reiterating the BRS's commitment to addressing the grievances of farmers and holding the government accountable for its promises and responsibilities.

Flood Victims Block Union Minister Kishan Reddy's Convoy in Khammam, Demand Relief

TPN, Telangana: On Sunday, September 8, flood-affected women in Khammam district blocked the convoy of Union Minister for Coal and Mines, G Kishan Reddy, to demand immediate relief. The minister, accompanied by Malkajgiri MP Etala Rajendran and Chevella MP Konda Vishweshwar Reddy, was inspecting flood-hit areas when his vehicle was stopped by the aggrieved group. The women complained that they had not received any support from the state government so far.

Kishan Reddy assured the group that the central government would provide all necessary assistance. Following the encounter, the BJP leaders distributed essential supplies to the affected families. Additionally, Reddy instructed local authorities to establish temporary shelters for those who had lost their homes due to the severe flooding.

In a social media post, Reddy recounted his visit to the flood-affected areas, specifically mentioning the 16th Division Dam-



salapuram in Khammam town. He stated, "I visited the areas inundated due to heavy floods and spoke with the victims. They informed me that there is no proper cooperation from the government regarding flood prevention and rehabilitation programs."

Reddy highlighted the need for coordinated efforts between the state and central governments to ensure proper relief and rehabilitation for those affected by the floods in Telangana.

KTR's tweet read, "Dear Revanth Reddy, congratulations! We are proud to congratulate you for transforming the state from being at the top of the Ease of Doing Business rankings to an unimaginable low. There are no words to describe this remarkable achievement." He further mocked the government's initiatives by referencing "innovations" such as Swachh Bio and Walls Karra, implying that these efforts were essential for the state's plummet in rankings.

KTR continued his critique by jesting about Reddy's future ambitions, suggesting that the Chief Minister should next address complex topics like nuclear chain reactions at the Davos Summit. He expressed skepticism about the administration's capabilities, noting, "Having achieved so much in just 9 months, it will be interesting to see what you accomplish in the next four years."

KTR concluded his tweet with a final note of mock congratulation, reinforcing his critical stance on the current government's handling of business environment improvements.

HYDRA Demolishes Farmhouse Linked to YCP Leader??



TPN, Telangana: The Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Protection Agency (HYDRA) continues its stringent actions against illegal constructions in the city's ponds and buffer zones, targeting high-profile individuals including movie stars, celebrities, political leaders, and businessmen. Recently, HYDRA issued demolition notices to Tollywood producer Murali Mohan for his illegal structures, and now, YSRCP leaders from neighboring Andhra Pradesh are also feeling the heat.

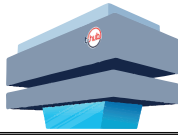
In a major development, HYDRA officials demolished the farmhouse allegedly belonging to senior YSRCP MLA Katasani Rambhupal Reddy in Swarnapuri, Hyderabad. The farmhouse, located in the Full Tank Level (FTL) and buffer zone of Amirpur in Sangareddy district, was brought down under heavy security. The demolition has sent shockwaves among political circles, particularly YCP leaders residing in Hyderabad, who are now reportedly anxious about further actions.

However, Katasani Rambhupal Reddy has denied ownership of the demolished farmhouse, asserting that it does not belong to him. Despite his denial, the HYDRA crackdown has intensified, with officials continuing their efforts to remove illegal constructions regardless of the individuals involved.

HYDRA demolishes ex-MLA's constructions on Ameenpur Lake



TPN Hyderabad : Hyderabad Disaster Response and Asset Monitoring and Protection Agency (HYDRA) demolished alleged illegal constructions by YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) leader and former MLA Katasani Rambhupal Reddy within the Full Tank Level (FTL) limits of Pedda Cheruvu in Ameenpur, Sangareddy district.

Rambhupal Reddy and his partner, Ramesh, were accused of encroaching on land near Ameenpur lake. The former MLA had constructed compound walls using concrete and metal sheets, claiming ownership of the land between two water bodies inside the lake's FTL limits. A criminal case has been filed against him.

The demolitions followed complaints from locals and environmentalists. Hyderabad Commissioner AV Ranganath inspected the site a week prior to the demolition. Encroachment issues surrounding the lake, which has an FTL area of 170 acres, were raised in a 2017 petition to the National Green Tribunal (NGT), and the hearing is ongoing. The Telangana government has declared the lake's FTL and buffer zone as a biodiversity heritage site.

Rambhupal Reddy has defended his actions, citing construction approval from the Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority (HMDA) in 1991 and a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the district collector in 2015. He claims that he legally acquired over 45 acres of land from local residents.

HYDRA clarified that no occupied homes will be demolished in their drive to reclaim city lakes. Instead, they are targeting new constructions, including compound walls, sheds, and businesses. HYDRA Chief AV Ranganath emphasized that encroachments often start with debris dumping and temporary structures, eventually leading to permanent constructions that threaten the existence of city lakes.

HYDRA orders Jayabheri Constructions to remove encroachments



TPN Hyderabad : Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring and Protection Agency (HYDRA) issued a directive to Jayabheri Constructions, owned by actor Murali Mohan, to remove encroachments from the Full Tank Level (FTL) and buffer zones around Rangalal Kunta lake in Gachibowli Financial District. The construction company has been given a 15-day deadline to clear the encroachments, or HYDRA will proceed with demolitions.

HYDRA Commissioner AV Ranganath explained that blue sheet walls erected by Jayabheri Constructions extend two meters into the FTL area. He noted that the agency had received complaints from local residents, prompting the action. Ranganath confirmed that the company had responded positively to the notice and agreed to comply with the removal request. In addition to this, HYDRA conducted demolitions in other areas of Hyderabad on the same day. In Madhapur, Dundigal, and Ameenpur, illegal constructions were targeted. A villa built by Lakshmi Srinivasa Construction, found in violation of regulations, was among the structures demolished. Numerous illegal sheds had been set up by encroachers, raising significant environmental concerns.

The demolitions were carried out under stringent security measures, with local police and municipal officials assisting in the process.

IIT-H Launches India's First In-Situ and Correlative Microscopy Centre

TPN Hyderabad : The Indian Institute of Technology-Hyderabad (IIT-H) has inaugurated the Centre for In-Situ and Correlative Microscopy (CISCoM), marking the establishment of India's first such microscopy centre. The unveiling took place on the institute's campus in Kandi, Sangareddy district, on Sunday, with the event attended by Secretary of the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Prof. Abhay Karandikar, Chairman of the Board of Governors, BVR Mohan Reddy, and IIT-H Director, Prof. BS Murty.

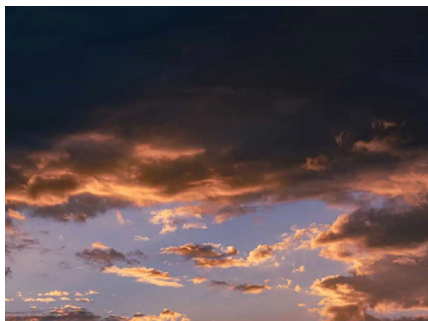

Additionally, 17 other institutes, including leading educational institutions, industries, and research centres, contributed an extra Rs 20 crore to support the initiative.

The centre aims to provide advanced microscopy solutions for a wide range of scientific and industrial applications, positioning IIT-H as a significant player in global research and technological innovation.

Telangana Faces Heavy Rainfall: IMD Issues Orange Alert



TPN Hyderabad : The India Meteorological Department (IMD) Hyderabad has issued a warning of very heavy rains expected over the next two days in various districts of Telangana. The department has also forecasted heavy rains for Tuesday, accompanied by thunderstorms, lightning, and squalls.

Due to the anticipated severe weather conditions, IMD Hyderabad has issued an orange

alert for the state. In addition, a yellow alert has been issued for Tuesday and Wednesday.

For Hyderabad, the IMD predicts light to moderate rainfall over the next four days, continuing through Wednesday.

On Saturday, significant rainfall was recorded in several districts. Mahabubabad and Khammam received 182.5 mm and 122 mm of rain, respectively. Rangareddy also experienced substantial rainfall, totaling 111.8 mm. In Hyderabad, the highest recorded rainfall was 6.3 mm in Shaikpet.

The ongoing Southwest Monsoon is expected to bring further increases in rainfall across Telangana, as per the IMD's latest forecasts.

Flood-Affected Women Block Union Minister's Convoy in Khammam



TPN Hyderabad : On Sunday, September 8, a group of women affected by recent flooding in Khammam district blocked the convoy of Union Minister for Coal and Mines, G Kishan Reddy, demanding immediate relief. Accompanied by Malkajgiri MP Etala Rajendran and Chevalla MP Konda Vishweshwar Reddy, Reddy was halted by the protestors who expressed frustration over the lack of assistance from the state government.

During the encounter, Reddy assured the women that the central government would provide the necessary support and relief. Following the confrontation, the BJP leaders distributed essential commodities to families impacted by the floods.

Reddy later inspected the flood-affected areas in Khammam, including the 16th Division Damsalapuram, and noted the extensive damage caused by the flooding. He instructed local authorities to establish temporary shelters for those who had lost their homes.

In a statement on his X handle, Reddy mentioned the lack of proper cooperation from the state government regarding flood prevention and rehabilitation efforts. The central government's response aims to address the immediate needs of the flood victims and support their recovery process.

Kolkata On Another Massive Protest, "Reclaim The Night"

City of Joy Turns Into a City of Rage, Demanding Justice for Victim



Kolkata, the City of Joy, has transformed into a city of protest and anguish as thousands take to the streets, demanding justice for a young doctor whose brutal rape and murder have left the city reeling. Almost a month after the horrific incident, the outrage continues to grow, with various groups uniting in solidarity, demanding swift justice for the victim and condemning the perceived inadequacies in the handling of the case by the authorities.

The most notable demonstration today was led by 58 alumni associations from various prestigious schools in South Kolkata. The streets of this usually posh area were thronged with protesters, a stark reminder of the ongoing discontent. Meanwhile, artists from across the city, including musicians, painters, and sculptors, joined the protest, each expressing their solidarity in unique ways.

At the heart of the protests is the rape-murder of a 31-year-old second-year postgraduate doctor from R G Kar Medical College, an incident that has triggered nationwide shock and outrage. The young doctor's body was discovered in a seminar room at the hospital on August 9, an event that has since sparked relentless protests, especially among the city's medical community.

Despite the Supreme Court's directions for doctors to return to work, junior doctors from R G Kar hospital have continued their protests, forming a powerful human chain at 5 pm today, holding the national flag and singing the national anthem in unison. These doctors, alongside hundreds of other demonstrators, are demanding accountability and transparency in the investigation, which they believe has been mishandled from the start.

Among the protesters was the victim's mother, a figure of both grief and strength. "Whenever I think about the torment, the pain my daughter experienced that night, I shudder," she said, tears streaming down her face. "She had dreams to serve society, but now those dreams are gone. These protesters, they are now all my children," she added, expressing her gratitude for the solidarity shown by the people of Kolkata and beyond.

The demonstrations were not confined to the medical community. The city's vibrant art scene also showed its support. In Tollygunge, Kolkata's famous film district, actors and filmmakers held their own rally, while students from art colleges created poignant graffiti at key intersections across the city, visually depicting the community's shared grief and anger. Sculptors from the historic Kumartuli area, busy preparing for the upcoming Durga Puja, took time out to organize their own protest, calling for justice for their "Durga"—a reference to the slain doctor, revered as a symbol of strength and courage.

Even Kolkata's rickshaw pullers joined the movement, adding a layer of grassroots solidarity to the protests. Their rally, though smaller in scale, was powerful in its message: no one in the city is untouched by the tragedy that has unfolded.

As the protests gained momentum, political leaders, civil society, and international voices began to join the chorus. Indian communities in 13 countries worldwide have expressed their intent to hold protests in solidarity with those

in Kolkata, underscoring the global resonance of this tragic case.

Bengal Government Faces Scrutiny

At the core of the anger is the way the Bengal government has handled the case, with accusations of incompetence and neglect surfacing from multiple quarters. The victim's parents have accused the police of a hasty cremation of their daughter's body and have alleged that they were offered money to remain silent about the case. These claims, along with concerns over the police investigation, have fueled public outrage and cast a shadow over the state's response to the crime.

The involvement of Sanjoy Roy, a civic volunteer with Kolkata Police, who has been arrested in connection with the crime, has only intensified the anger. Roy, who was stationed at the hospital's police outpost and had access to all departments, is accused of committing the heinous crime. The victim's body was found in a seminar room, a space within the hospital that Roy had access to. While Roy has been taken into custody, questions have been raised about the systemic lapses that allowed such an atrocity to occur within the hospital premises.

Adding to the controversy are allegations of financial irregularities against the hospital's former principal, Sandip Ghosh, who has been implicated in a separate scandal. These allegations have further muddied the waters, leading many to question the integrity of the hospital's administration and its ability to provide justice for the victim.

"Reclaim The Night" Protest to Follow

In a powerful demonstration of defiance and solidarity, women across Kolkata are set to stage a "Reclaim the Night" protest later tonight, beginning at 11 pm. This demonstration is expected to draw participants from various fields, including musicians, artists, and actors, all rallying under the common cause of seeking justice for the victim. The protest is symbolic of the city's broader demand for women's safety and autonomy in public spaces, a message that resonates deeply in the wake of this brutal crime.

The protest is expected to spread beyond the city center, with rallies planned in suburban areas such as Barrackpore, Barasat, Budgebudge, Belgharia, Agarpara, Dumdum, and Baguiati. Each of these regions has been actively involved in the movement, organizing protests that highlight the widespread anger across the state.

Central Bureau of Investigation Steps In

The case has now been handed over to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) following an order from the Calcutta High Court, which intervened amid growing concerns over the local police's ability to conduct a fair and transparent investigation. The CBI's involvement has been welcomed by many, who hope that it will bring much-needed clarity and justice to the case.

The city of Kolkata remains on edge, with protests continuing to mount as the public demands accountability. The memory of the young doctor, a woman whose life was brutally cut short, has become a rallying point for a city that refuses to be silent in the face of injustice.

India's Rising Global Role as PM Modi Sends Ajit Doval With Russia-Ukraine Peace Plan

India's independent foreign policy has positioned it uniquely as a potential peacemaker in the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict. While Europe and its western allies find themselves locked in a stalemate with Russia, which has been backed by China, India is emerging as a key player that opens a third axis in a largely bipolar geopolitical world.

In recent developments, National Security Adviser (NSA) Ajit Doval is set to travel to Moscow this week to hold crucial discussions related to a peace plan for the Russia-Ukraine war. His visit comes shortly after Prime Minister Narendra Modi's historic trip to Ukraine and follows a series of diplomatic engagements with Russian President Vladimir Putin.

India's Independent Stance and Global Influence

India's foreign policy, marked by non-alignment and independence, has allowed it to maintain friendly ties with both Russia and Ukraine throughout the conflict. This diplomatic flexibility has created an opportunity for India to potentially broker peace between the two warring nations.

This move follows a string of high-level communications, with the Russian Embassy confirming that Putin had shared his assessment of the "destructive policies" of Kyiv and its Western patrons during his call with Modi. Doval's mission will be crucial in advancing the discussions and possibly

charting a path towards peace.

Global Reactions to India's Peacemaking Efforts

Assam Implements Stricter Aadhaar Card Regulations to Curb Illegal Immigration

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma announced that new Aadhaar card applicants in the state will be required to submit their National Register of Citizens (NRC) Application Receipt Number (ARN) starting October 1. This new procedure aims to prevent illegal immigrants from obtaining Aadhaar cards, the CM stated in a press conference. Sarma revealed that Aadhaar applications in Assam have exceeded the population in several districts, raising concerns about "doubtful citizens." In response, the government will only issue Aadhaar cards to new applicants after a thorough vetting process, including a no-objection certificate from the district commissioner. Exemptions from this requirement will be granted to those whose biometrics were locked during the NRC process and individuals from tea garden areas. The government aims to block illegal foreigners by strengthening border patrols and intelligence efforts. Additionally, local residents in border areas will be encouraged to report suspicious activities, aiding in early detection of illegal migrants. Since January 2024, 54 illegal immigrants have been detected in Assam, with 45 being repatriated and nine arrested. Sarma emphasized the importance of intensified efforts to identify and document illegal immigrants, urging collaboration with local authorities and law enforcement. This move underscores Assam's commitment to addressing



the issue of illegal immigration while tightening security and ensuring transparency in Aadhaar card issuance.

Rahul Gandhi Receives Warm Welcome from Indian Diaspora in Dallas During US Visit



On Sunday, September 8, Rahul Gandhi, Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, expressed his gratitude to the Indian Diaspora and members of the Indian Overseas Congress for the warm reception he received in Dallas, Texas. In a Facebook post, Gandhi shared, "I am truly delighted by the warm welcome I've received in Dallas, Texas, USA, from the Indian Diaspora and members of the Indian Overseas Congress." The post, accompanied by seven photos of him being greeted with bouquets, quickly garnered over 39,000 likes. Gandhi mentioned that he looks forward to engaging in meaningful discussions to strengthen the bond between India and the U.S. during his visit. Rahul Gandhi's U.S. visit began on Friday, marking his first international tour since the June Lok Sabha elections. His schedule includes meetings with business and academic leaders. In Dallas, he met with the Indian Diaspora at the Toyota Music Factory. On Monday, September 9, Gandhi is scheduled to address another gathering of the Indian Diaspora in Washington DC at the Hilton Washington Dulles hotel. According to Congress national media panellist Surendra Rajput, Gandhi will discuss "the India of his dreams" and outline the Congress party's vision for the future.

TMC MP Jawhar Sircar Resigns Over RG Kar Hospital Rape-Murder Case and Corruption

Trinamool Congress (TMC) MP and former IAS officer Jawhar Sircar resigned from his Rajya Sabha seat on September 8, citing disillusionment with politics and corruption at Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital. Sircar's resignation comes in the wake of public outrage over the alleged rape and murder of a trainee doctor at the hospital. In his resignation letter to TMC Chairperson Mamata Banerjee, Sircar stated that his decision was driven by the unchecked corruption at RG Kar Hospital and the government's delayed response to the incident. He expressed disappointment with the lack of direct intervention from Banerjee, adding that punitive actions came "too little, too late." Sircar joined politics to fight communalism and the BJP's authoritarianism but said the situation in West Bengal has become untenable. He emphasized that the protests against the hospital incident were spontaneous and apolitical, driven by the youth and public demanding justice, not political gain. Sircar also criticized the growing corruption within TMC, admitting he was "shocked" by the behavior of some leaders.



Ajit Pawar Admits 'Mistake', Urges Minister's Daughter Not to Oppose Father



Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar, in a public address at Gadchiroli, admitted once again that splitting his party and family was a mistake. His comments came in light of Bhagyashree Atram, daughter of state minister Dharmarao Baba Atram, considering joining the Sharad Pawar faction and contesting against her father in Aheri. Ajit Pawar urged Bhagyashree not to challenge her father, stating, "Stay with your father. No one can love his daughter as much as a father does. By doing this, you will create a rift in your own house." Reflecting on his own political decisions, Pawar Junior, who split from his uncle Sharad Pawar's Nationalist Congress Party to join the BJP and Eknath Shinde's Shiv Sena last year, acknowledged his mistake. "We have also gained experience in this context, and I have now understood my mistake and I accept it." Pawar's comments echo his previous admissions about fielding his wife, Sunetra Pawar, against his cousin, Supriya Sule, in Baramati during the last Lok Sabha election, where his faction performed poorly.

Former RG Kar Hospital Principal Arrested for Alleged Criminal Nexus and Financial Irregularities



Former RG Kar Medical College principal Sandip Ghosh has been arrested by the CBI for allegedly running a criminal nexus aimed at securing financial gains through personal connections. The arrest follows an investigation into contracts awarded during his tenure, which reportedly caused significant losses to the government. Along with Ghosh, two vendors and his security guard were also apprehended last month. The CBI's investigation revealed that Ghosh had close ties with the two vendors since his posting at Murshidabad Medical College from 2016 to 2018. After assuming the principal position at RG Kar, Ghosh allegedly favored these vendors by awarding them contracts for material supplies to the hospital, bypassing due process. The probe also implicated Ghosh's security guard, who was reportedly involved in selling the hospital's biomedical waste. Further accusations include irregularities in the appointment of house staff, where committee signatures were missing from documents in 2022 and 2023, indicating arbitrary selection processes. Additionally, the CBI found that Ghosh had awarded a café contract inside the hospital to an organization connected to his security guard's wife.

Manipur Government Seeks Control Over Unified Command Amid Escalating Violence



Amid rising violence in Manipur, Chief Minister N Biren Singh and 18 MLAs met Governor L Acharya, demanding control over the Unified Command, which currently oversees security operations in the state. The Manipur government has called on the central government to hand over the Home Ministry-run command and terminate the Suspension of Operations agreement with Kuki insurgent groups. The demand for control comes after Kuki militants launched long-range rocket attacks in Bishnupur, killing a 78-year-old man and injuring six others. With violence escalating, reports suggest a possible leadership crisis within the ruling BJP in Manipur. An all-party meeting in January had previously called for the suspension agreement to be scrapped, allowing security forces to conduct full-scale operations against insurgents. The Unified Command, presently managed by Union Home Ministry officials, the state security adviser, and the Army, plays a key role in coordinating security efforts in the violence-hit state. BJP MLA Rajkumar Imo Singh, son-in-law of CM Biren Singh, had also criticized the presence of 60,000 central forces, claiming they have failed to restore peace in Manipur. Opposition leader Keisham Meghachandra Singh expressed concerns over the central government's handling of the situation, likening it to an enforcement of Article 355, which restricts state powers in crisis situations. He questioned why the violence continues unabated, echoing the sentiment across the state.

Rajnath Singh: India Ready for Talks if Pakistan Stops Sponsoring Terrorism



Defence Minister Rajnath Singh stated today that India is open to dialogue with Pakistan, but only if the neighboring country halts its support for terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir. Singh made the remarks during an election rally in Banihal, Ramban district, where the BJP has fielded Mohd Saleem Bhat. Speaking at the rally, Singh emphasized India's desire for improved relations with Pakistan, but underscored that the cessation of terrorism is a prerequisite. "You can change a friend, but not your neighbor," Singh said, stressing that the normalization of ties depends on Pakistan's actions. He also pointed out that 85% of those killed in terrorist incidents in Kashmir were Muslims, highlighting the widespread impact of terrorism. Singh, a former Home Minister, reiterated that terror activities in the region have disproportionately harmed the local population. Singh's comments come in the context of India's long-standing concerns about Pakistan's support for terror outfits like Lashkar-e-Taiba. Terror attacks in Jammu and Kashmir had declined when Pakistan was placed on the Financial Action Task Force's (FATF) grey list, but Singh emphasized that despite Pakistan's removal from the list, the scrutiny continues. The rally was held in support of BJP candidate Mohd Saleem Bhat, who is contesting against Congress's Vikar Rasool Wani in the upcoming Jammu and Kashmir elections. Voting will be held in three phases, with results expected on October 8.

S Jaishankar's Key Gulf Meet In Saudi Arabia



India is making significant strides in enhancing its international relationships with a series of high-profile diplomatic engagements. External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar has embarked on a pivotal diplomatic journey starting with his participation in the First India-Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) Foreign Ministers' Meeting in Saudi Arabia. The meeting will provide a platform to review and deepen India's multifaceted ties with the GCC member countries, which include Saudi Arabia, the UAE, Bahrain, Qatar, Kuwait, and Oman. The GCC region, a major trading partner for India, is also home to approximately 8.9 million Indian expatriates.

Following the GCC engagement, Jaishankar will head to Berlin, Germany, for a two-day visit from September 10 to 11. This visit marks his third as External Affairs Minister and underscores the strong strategic partnership between India and Germany. Germany remains one of India's key trading partners and a significant source of Foreign Direct Investment. Jaishankar's European tour will continue with a visit to Geneva, Switzerland, from September 12 to 13, where he will engage with heads and representatives of international organizations actively involved with India. In parallel developments, the Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi, Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed

bin Zayed Al Nahyan, is set to visit India from September 9 to 10. During this two-day visit, he will meet Prime Minister Narendra Modi to discuss and enhance bilateral cooperation. In a recent address at the CII India Mediterranean Business Conclave, Jaishankar emphasized the importance of revitalizing connections with the Mediterranean region. He highlighted the need for stronger security and defense cooperation amid global economic uncertainties and stressed the region's potential in green hydrogen and green ammonia. Jaishankar's remarks reflect a broader commitment to building resilient and collaborative international partnerships.



India Engages in Peace Efforts as NSA Doval Prepares for Moscow Talks

In a significant diplomatic development, Russian President Vladimir Putin has identified India as one of the key countries engaged in dialogue regarding the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict. National Security Advisor Ajit Doval is scheduled to travel to Moscow this week to participate in discussions aimed at resolving the conflict, sources have confirmed. This initiative follows recent high-profile visits by Prime Minister Narendra Modi to both Russia and Ukraine. During these visits, Modi met with Russian President Vladimir Putin and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky. After his visit to Ukraine, Modi spoke with Putin on August 27, where he emphasized India's commitment to resolving the conflict through political and diplomatic means. The call led to the decision for NSA Doval to head to Moscow for further peace talks. Bangladesh Seeks Extradition of Former PM Sheikh Hasina from India

In the wake of massive anti-government protests that culminated on August 5, former Bangladeshi Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina resigned and fled to India. Bangladesh's newly-appointed Chief Prosecutor for the International Crimes Tribunal (ICT), Md Tajul Islam, announced on Sunday that efforts will be made to extradite Hasina from India to face charges of mass killings linked to the student-led protests. Islam stated that an application will be filed with the ICT to issue arrest warrants for Hasina and others accused of crimes against humanity. The tribunal plans to review and amend its existing legislation to accommodate these new cases. The interim government has reported over 1,000 deaths and hundreds of injuries during the protests against Hasina's administration. The ICT had recently initiated an investigation into these allegations. The tribunal's team will be reconstituted following the transition to the interim government led by Nobel laureate Muhammad Yunus.

Italian PM Meloni Highlights Role of India and China in Ukraine Conflict Resolution

Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni emphasized the potential roles of China and India in resolving the Ukraine conflict during the Ambrosetti Forum in Cernobbio on Saturday. Her comments followed a meeting with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky, where they discussed Ukraine's urgent needs and the latest developments on the ground. Meloni highlighted that economic globalization and adherence to international law are incompatible with ongoing crises, suggesting that major global players like China and India must actively contribute to resolving the conflict. This perspective aligns with recent remarks by Russian President Vladimir Putin, who also acknowledged India's potential role in providing a "helping hand." Zelensky's office reported that the Ukrainian president expressed gratitude for international military and technical assistance and stressed the urgency of transferring relevant weapons. Discussions also covered the implementation of the G7 decision to provide nearly USD 50 billion from frozen Russian assets for Ukraine's recovery and reconstruction, including its energy infrastructure.

Police Foil Attempted Arms Loot in Manipur; Unverified UFO Sighting Reported



In a tense incident late Friday evening, security forces successfully thwarted an attempt by miscreants to loot arms from the 7th and 2nd Manipur Rifles battalions in Imphal East district. According to Manipur Police, the attempted theft occurred at the armouries of the two battalions. The combined security forces responded by deploying teargas shells and blank rounds, effectively dispersing the mob. A senior police officer reported that during the operation to disperse the mob, some vehicles belonging to the miscreants were damaged. Additionally, as the reinforcement party was returning from the 7th Battalion in Khabeisoi, they came under fire from the miscreants, resulting in injuries to two policemen. Senior officers quickly arrived on the scene to restore control. The Manipur Police have urged the public to refrain from taking the law into their own hands, warning that those involved in such activities will face severe legal consequences. The ongoing ethnic violence in Manipur, which began in May last year, has led to the looting of over 4,000 sophisticated arms and large quantities of ammunition from police and security posts. However, security forces have since recovered a significant portion of the looted arms and ammunition.

Indian Foreign Minister S Jaishankar to Visit Germany and Switzerland

External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar is set to travel to Germany and Switzerland this week following his participation in the First India-Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) Foreign Ministers' Meeting in Riyadh. Jaishankar will arrive in Berlin on Tuesday for a two-day visit, his third as Foreign Minister. During his stay, he will meet German Federal Foreign Minister Annalena Baerbock and other German officials to review and strengthen bilateral relations. Germany remains a key trading partner and major investor for India. Following his visit to Germany, Jaishankar will proceed to Geneva from September 12 to 13. There, he will engage with Swiss Foreign Minister and representatives of international organizations based in the city, including the WHO and UNHCR. The discussions will focus on enhancing the bilateral relationship and reviewing ongoing partnerships. India continues to pursue a permanent seat on the United Nations Security Council, with support from several key nations, though China remains a notable obstacle.

Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi Begins Historic Visit to India

Crown Prince Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan of Abu Dhabi arrived in New Delhi on Sunday for his first official visit to India in his current role. Accompanied by UAE government ministers and a business delegation, the Crown Prince was warmly welcomed at the airport by Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal. During his visit, Sheikh Khaled will meet with Prime Minister Narendra Modi on September 9 to discuss a broad range of bilateral cooperation areas. He is also scheduled to meet President Droupadi Murmu and visit Rajghat to pay tribute to Mahatma Gandhi. On September 10, the Crown Prince will head to Mumbai to participate in a business forum involving leaders from both countries.

The visit aims to strengthen the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership between India and the UAE, which has expanded to cover political, trade, investment, energy, technology, and cultural sectors. The two nations' trade reached USD 85 billion in 2022, making the UAE India's third-largest trading partner and second-largest export destination. This visit follows UAE President Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan's trip to India in January and Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to the UAE in July. The India-UAE relationship was formally upgraded to a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership in 2017.

India's Equity Markets Decline Ends Streak of Gains

India's equity markets experienced a significant decline last week, breaking a three-week streak of gains. The Nifty index fell by 1.52% and the Sensex by 1.43% from September 2 to September 6.

The drop in benchmark indices was influenced by weaker global economic indicators. "One major factor contributing to this decline is the recent weak job data from the USA, which has heightened concerns about a possible global economic slowdown," analysts noted. Furthermore, India's weight in the MSCI Emerging Markets index has surpassed that of China, reaching a record high. This could lead to a strategic reduction in weight allocation due to India's relatively high valuations.

The market outlook for the coming week will be influenced by both global and domestic factors. Globally, attention is focused on the upcoming US Federal Reserve meeting in mid-September, with many anticipating a potential cut in interest rates.

Domestically, key developments include the release of August's inflation figures by the Indian government on September 12. Investors will also monitor the Rupee's performance against the dollar, fluctua-



tions in crude oil prices, and the investment patterns of foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) and domestic institutional investors (DIIs).

Pravesh Gour, Senior Technical Analyst at Swastika Investmart Ltd, highlighted that "last week, signs of weakness appeared in the Nifty index. The main index closed just above 24,850, a crucial support level. If it falls below this, it could drop to 24,000. The support range for Nifty is between 24,600 and 24,450, while resistance is seen between 25,000 and 25,200."

Palka Arora Chopra, Director at Master Capital Services Ltd, added that "Nifty Bank closed below 50,800 last week. Currently, 50,500 is an important support level; if breached, the index might test 49,800. Key resistance levels for Nifty Bank are 51,200 and 51,800."

Adani Group Expands Global Reach with New Subsidiary in Shanghai, China

Adani Group has announced the establishment of a new subsidiary in China, as detailed in a recent regulatory filing. The subsidiary, named Adani Energy Resources (Shanghai) Co. (AER-CL), will focus on providing supply chain solutions and project management services. The move reflects the group's ongoing expansion into global markets.

According to the filing, Adani Enterprises, the flagship company of the Adani Group, reported that the new subsidiary was incorporated on September 2, 2024. This entity, based in Shanghai, China, was created through a Singapore-based step-down subsidiary of the group.

This strategic expansion into the Chinese market aims to bolster Adani's international footprint and enhance its capabilities in managing supply chains and projects across the region. The establishment of AERCL aligns with the Adani Group's broader global strategy, seeking to leverage emerging market opportunities and strengthen its operational presence in key international markets.

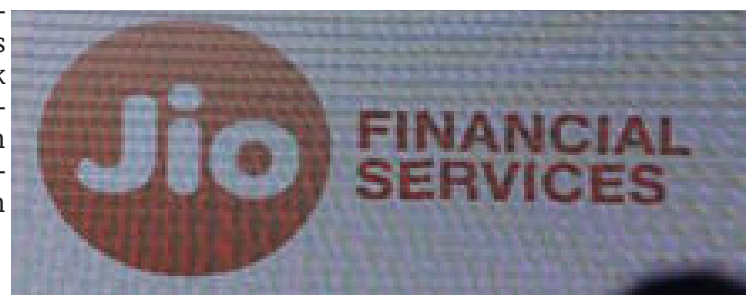

Jio Financial Services and BlackRock Form Joint Venture for Investment Advisory

On September 6, BlackRock Advisors Singapore Pte. Ltd. and Jio Financial Services launched a joint venture named Jio BlackRock Investment Advisers Private Limited, according to a Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) filing on September 8. The new company aims to provide primary investment advisory services in India, pending regulatory approvals.



Jio Financial Services, the non-banking financial services arm of Mukesh Ambani's conglomerate, will initially invest ₹3 crore for the subscription of 30 lakh shares, each with a face value of ₹10. The investment is part of the company's commitment to establishing the joint venture.

Following the announcement, Jio Financial Services' shares closed at ₹336.90 on Friday, marking a 2.45% decline from the previous day's close of ₹345.35. The

joint venture's incorporation was officially recognized with a Certificate of Incorporation from the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) on September 7.

The formation of Jio BlackRock Investment Advisers Private Limited represents a significant move by Jio Financial Services to expand its footprint in the investment advisory sector, leveraging BlackRock's global expertise.

Delhi Finance Minister to Challenge GST on Research Grants and Small Online Transactions

Delhi Finance Minister Atishi has announced plans to raise concerns at the 54th GST Council meeting regarding the imposition of GST on research grants and small online transactions. Addressing a press conference, Atishi criticized the central government's 18% GST on research grants received by educational institutions from private entities. She argued that this tax is unjustified, particularly given that such grants are not taxed in countries like the US and the UK.



Atishi also expressed opposition to a new proposal for imposing GST on online transactions under

Rs 2,000, which was previously exempt from such taxes. She emphasized that the government's recent move to apply GST to these smaller transactions would be contested.

The GST Council meeting, scheduled for Monday, will be a platform for Atishi to argue against these measures, aiming to protect educational institutions and small online transactions from additional tax burdens.

GST Council Led by Nirmala Sitharaman to Review Taxation on Life Insurance Premiums

The GST Council is set to meet on Monday to address several key issues, including the potential reduction of GST on life insurance premiums and a status report on online gaming. The meeting, chaired by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, will include discussions on various taxation matters.

Sources indicate that the fitment committee, composed of central and state tax officials, will present a report on GST rates applied to life, health, and reinsurance premiums. This report will include an analysis of the revenue implications of potential changes in these rates.

One major topic of discussion will be whether to lower the GST rate on health insurance premiums from the current 18% or to consider exemptions for specific groups, such as senior citizens. The decision could



significantly impact the cost of health insurance for these individuals.

Additionally, the council will review recommendations from the Group of Ministers (GoM) on rate rationalization and consider a status report on online gaming taxation. The outcomes of these discussions could lead to substantial changes in how various services and sectors are taxed under the GST framework.



Everything to Know About Taliban’s New “Vice and Virtue” Law in Afghanistan



The Taliban government in Afghanistan has introduced a new law to “promote virtue and prevent vice,” codifying strict rules for Afghan society based on their interpretation of Islam. Evidence of the law’s enforcement by the Taliban morality police and Afghans self-policing has emerged in recent days. However, while some elements are being enforced, others remain pending. The Taliban has been clamping down on behaviors they deem un-Islamic since they returned to power three years ago.

Key Aspects of the New Law



The new “Vice and Virtue” law comprises 35 articles, some of which have sparked controversy. Among the most criticized rules is a mandate that a woman’s voice should not be raised outside the home, and that women should not sing or recite poetry aloud. The law forbids unrelated men and women from looking at each other, and women must fully cover themselves in front of non-Muslim women.

Other provisions include:

- Men must grow beards longer than a fist, wear loose-fitting clothing, and not reveal their bodies from the navel to the knee.
- Sodomy is banned, even between spouses.
- The media is prohibited from mocking or humiliating Islam.
- Transport companies must alter schedules to align with prayer times.
- Muslims are instructed not to befriend or assist non-Muslims.

The law also bans certain traditional games and the taking or viewing of photos of living beings on computers or smartphones. Disobedience to parents has also been criminalized.

Social Impact and Enforcement



Since the law’s announcement on August 21, enforcement has been ramped up by morality police from the Ministry for the Propagation of Virtue and the Prevention of Vice. Patrols in Kabul have warned women traveling without a male “mahram” (chaperone) and those with hair or hands showing. In Mazar-e-Sharif, taxi drivers have been warned not to transport women without a mahram or those not fully covered.

Men have also faced increased scrutiny. A young man in Kabul shared that he was stopped three times and questioned about not having a beard, while staff in a Kabul bank swapped their Western attire for traditional dress in response to the new law.

Despite this, there are still reports of women’s voices being heard on TV and radio, suggesting that some aspects of the law have not been fully enforced yet.

Previous Restrictions

Since the Taliban’s return to power in 2021, they have implemented several social restrictions, many of which overlap with the new law. Girls have long been banned from secondary schools, and women are prohibited from attending universities. Women traveling must already be chaperoned and fully covered in public.

Other long-standing bans include public music, gambling, adultery, homosexuality, and drug addiction. The new law builds on these existing restrictions and provides a more comprehensive framework, including graduated punishments for violations ranging from verbal warnings to fines and detentions.

Ambiguities in the Law

Despite the strict rules, the law leaves several grey areas and unanswered questions. For instance, it states that women should only leave home for an “urgent need” but does not specify what qualifies as urgent. It also bans friendship and assistance to non-Muslims, raising concerns about whether Afghans are allowed to work with international organizations, which are crucial for Afghanistan’s struggling economy.

Additionally, the law’s media restrictions are vague, and it remains unclear how authorities will regulate content on phones and television.

A United Nations report from July noted “ambiguities and inconsistencies” around morality measures before this new law was introduced. It remains to be seen how uniformly and strictly the Taliban will enforce the new rules, particularly given the opaque nature of their government.

Conclusion



The Taliban’s new “Vice and Virtue” law codifies their vision for Afghan society with stringent controls over personal behavior. While some elements of the law are already being enforced, many questions remain about its full impact, especially concerning women’s rights and interactions with international organizations. How these laws will be uniformly applied, and the Taliban’s ability to enforce them, will likely shape the future of Afghan society under their rule.

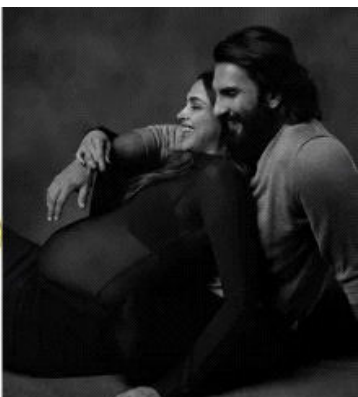
