Activists Pay Tributes to Prof. GN Saibaba at Gun **Park Memorial**

TPN , Hyderabad: Hyderabad, Oct 14: Human rights activists and political leaders gathered at the Gun Park Martyrs Memorial near the Telangana Assembly on Monday to pay their final respects to Professor GN Saibaba, who passed away on October 13 following complications from gall bladder surgery at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences.

Despite the tension, the activists paid tribute to Saibaba by raising "Laal Salaam" slogans before departing for Moula Ali, where his remains were to be donated to Gandhi Medical College for re-

Professor Kasim, a close associate, recalled Saibaba's pivotal role in mobilizing two lakh people for a massive public meeting in Warangal in December 1998, which culminated in the historic 'Warangal Declaration' in support of the Telangana statehood movement. Kasim

noted that even former Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao had acknowledged the significance of the Warangal Declaration during his address in the assembly after assuming office in 2014.

"Saibaba was a relentless advocate for quality education, equal opportunities, and healthcare for all. He also defended

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
CM Chandrababu Announced Ratan Tata Innovation Hub in Amaravati

AP High Court Rejects Ponnavolu Sudhakar Reddy's Petition for **Police Security**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Ponnavolu Sudhakar Reddy, a senior lawyer and former Additional Advocate General in Andhra Pradesh, faced a setback in the state High Court as his petition seeking police security was dismissed. The High Court ruled that Ponnavolu does not require police protection, upholding the findings of the state's Security Review Committee, which had

previously determined there was no threat to

The court's decision came after lengthy arguments, during which Ponnavolu argued for continued police security. However, the High Court bench reserved its judgment and, following a detailed review, announced the ver-



dict today, rejecting Ponnavolu's request.

Earlier in the hearings, the court had already expressed doubts about the necessity of police protection for Ponnavolu, referring to the conclusions of the Security Review Committee. The court had suggested that if Ponnavolu had objections to the committee's findings, he should challenge their re-

port. Despite this, the High Court maintained its stance, leaving Ponnavolu disappointed with the final ruling.

This verdict marks a significant moment in Ponnavolu's legal career, as the senior advocate lost the case he personally fought for.

YCP Leaders Attended Police **Interrogation in TDP Office Attack Case**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Leaders from the YSR Congress Party (YCP), including Devineni Avinash, Lella Appireddy, and Talashila Raghuram, attended questioning at the Mangalagiri Rural Police Station in connection with the attack on the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) central office. The police are investigating several aspects of the case, including the whereabouts of the leaders on the morning of the

attack, their meeting locations, and the areas they frequented.

Recently, orders were issued to transfer this case to the Crime Investigation Department (CID); however, the delivery was delayed due to some technical reasons. In the meantime, the Mangalagiri police continue their investigation.



The incident occurred on October 19, 2021, during the YCP's regime when followers of Alla Ramakrishna Reddy, along with Avinash and Appireddy, reportedly attacked the TDP office. This incident has raised significant concerns about political violence in the region, prompting authorities to take action against those involved.

As the investigation unfolds, the involvement of YCP leaders in the questioning reflects the seriousness with which law enforcement is treating this case, aiming to ensure accountability for the violence against the TDP office. The public and political observers will be closely monitoring developments as the CID prepares to take over the investigation.

TPN, Hyderabad: Renowned choreographer Johnny Master has suffered a legal setback as the Ranga Reddy District Court rejected his bail petition in a case of sexual assault. Johnny Master was arrested following allegations that he had sexually assaulted an assistant choreographer. He is currently being held at Chanchalguda Jail in Hyderabad.

The choreographer had recently filed for bail in the Ranga Reddy District POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offenses) Court. However, after a thorough hearing, the court dismissed his petition. Johnny Master had been taken into custody by Narsinghi police for a four-day interrogation, conducted with court approval.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh government has intensified its approach to several high-profile cases by transferring the investigation of the Kadambari Jethwani case to the Crime Investigation Department (CID). This move follows a series of violent incidents that have raised concerns about security and law enforcement in the state.

In recent developments, the state police have transferred numerous significant cases to the CID, signaling a shift in strategy to ensure more thorough investigations. Among these cases are the attacks on the residence of former Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and the central office of the Telugu Desam Party (TDP). The attacks, which have drawn considerable public and media attention, have led to heightened security measures and calls for accountability.

So far, more than 110 cases related to these violent

incidents have been registered, resulting in the arrest of over 30 individuals. The government has expressed its commitment to bringing the culprits to justice and restoring peace in the affected ar-

Mangalagiri Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) is scheduled to hand over the files related to the Kadambari Jethwani case to the CID today. This transfer is part of a broader effort to enhance the efficacy of investigations into attacks that have sparked fear and unrest among citizens.

The decision to involve the CID reflects the government's determination to address the ongoing security challenges and to ensure that those responsible for violent acts are held accountable. With this proactive stance, the Andhra Pradesh government aims to bolster public confidence in law enforcement agencies and create a safer environment for its citizens.

As the CID takes charge of the Jethwani case and other significant investigations, the public will be watching closely to see how effectively these cases are resolved and whether justice will be served in the wake of these violent events.

The competition is especially fierce in the NTR district, where an average of 52 applications were received per shop, with 132 applications for one location and 120 for another. Eluru, East Godavari, Guntur, Vizianagaram, and West Godavari districts are also seeing high demand, with many shops receiving over 70 applications. In contrast, political interference has led to fewer applications in Tirupati and Sri Satyasai districts, where only 17 applicants are competing

for each shop, indicating a formed syndicate allocation of these liquor shops, overseen by district collectors. Each shop will have a separate lottery draw, and officials are making security arrangements for the event. The new liquor pol-

icy has proven profitable, generating substantial revenue, with an anticipated ₹300 crores from the first installment of the license fee due within 24 hours of winning the lottery.

Successful applicants can begin operations as early as Wednesday, October 16, after purchasing a week's worth of inventory, which is expected to further increase state revenue to around ₹2,400 crores in the initial phase of the new policy.

MLA Dhulipalla Narendra Allegations Against YCP Coordinator Ambati Muralikrishna



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: TDP MLA Dhulipalla Narendra Kumar has leveled serious allegations against YSR Congress Party (YCP) Ponnur constituency co ordinator Ambati Muralikrishna, accusing him of illegal activities related to the Eluru Jute Mill and unauthorized construction projects.

Speaking to the media in Ponnur, Dhulipalla claimed that Ambati Muralikrishna, after becoming the director of the Eluru Jute Mill, illegally seized the mill for his own benefit. He further criticized Muralikrishna for committing various illegalities during the previous government by obstructing authorities and misusing his power.

Dhulipalla also alleged irregularities in the construction of the Green Grace Apartments in Guntur. He claimed that Ambati Muralikrishna had obtained approval from Guntur Corporation officials for constructing a G Plus 5 (ground

floor plus five floors) building but violated norms by building 15 floors. Additionally, he pointed out that the project has yet to receive the necessary clearance from the railway department, which has not granted permission for the construction.

Referring to his own legal history, Dhulipalla stated that 30 years ago, he was involved in a case related to Sangam Dairy and was sent to jail. However, he emphasized that he faced the charges and did not shy away from the legal process. He further asserted that despite numerous attempts to file illegal cases against him, he does not need the support of a political party to succeed in politics.

These allegations have added to the growing political tension between the TDP and YCP in the region. Ambati Muralikrishna has not yet responded to the accusations.

He alleged that the new liquor policy was designed to benefit liquor manufacturers rather than the people of Andhra Pradesh. "The policy only serves to enrich the liquor barons," Venugopalakrishna said, questioning the decision to extend the deadline for liquor tender applications by two days. He expressed indignation, suggesting that

the move might be to encourage further alcohol consumption in the state.

TDP Cadre Protest Against Minister Kandula Durgesh in **East Godavari**



TPN, **Andhra Pradesh**: Four months into the coalition government in Andhra Pradesh, cracks within the alliance have begun to surface. The latest in a string of protests comes from the ranks of the Telugu Desam Party (TDP), this time targeting Janasena Minister Kandula Durgesh. The TDP cadre, who had helped the coalition win in Nidadavolu, expressed their anger over being sidelined since the formation of the government.

The incident occurred in Kansalipalem village, Nidadavolu, where Minister Durgesh arrived to participate in a state-wide village festival program. Local TDP workers, who played a crucial role in his victory, were furious about being neglected ever since Durgesh assumed office. They voiced their frustrations, claiming they were left in the dark regarding the village festival and felt ignored by the minister.

The TDP supporters pointed out that despite their support during the election, they have not received any recognition or attention from Durgesh since he became a minister. Some even warned that without their backing, his electoral victory would not have been possible, reminding him of their significant contribution.

Tensions rose further as those who had come in support of the minister from Kadiam felt insulted by the local protesters. In an attempt to defuse the situation, Minister Durgesh assured the protestors that he would work towards addressing their grievances and include them in future plans. He promised to mobilize efforts to ensure that all members of the coalition are involved going forward.

The protest against Durgesh has caused a political stir in East Godavari, highlighting growing dissatisfaction within the ruling coalition, and raising questions about unity ahead of upcoming elections.

YS Sharmila Slams AP Govt Over Liquor Syndicate Allegations

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Andhra Pradesh Congress Committee (APCC) Chief YS Sharmila Reddy launched a scathing attack on the Andhra Pradesh government, led by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, accusing it of rampant corruption and collusion in the liquor trade. Sharmila criticized the CM's recent claim of no political interference in government operations, questioning the government's role in stopping liquor syndicates.

In a fiery statement, Sharmila alleged that ruling party leaders have formed a syndicate to control liquor shops across the state. She claimed that more than 3,000 liquor shops have been handed over to syndicates, undermining any pretense of transparency or impartiality. According to her, the tender process for liquor licenses was conducted under the influence of ministers, MLAs, and MPs, preventing fair competition.

She further accused the ruling coalition of using intimidation tactics across the state to ensure that liquor shops remain inaccessi-

ble to the common people. "They threatened

those who weren't part of the alliance syndicates, warning them with life-threatening consequences," she said. Sharmila raised concerns about the fate of those who accidentally won liquor licenses through the lottery system, questioning whether these individuals would be granted licenses or forced to give a 30% commission to the syndicate—or face even graver threats.

Sharmila also attacked the government for allegedly facilitating large-scale corruption through the private sale of liquor under the guise of lower prices. She claimed that the alliance government has orchestrated a robbery worth thousands of crores and warned that these alleged wrongdoings could surface in the future.

Drawing parallels with the previous YCP government, Sharmila commented, "If the previous YCP swallowed temple money with their 'cash-only' schemes, now you are devouring people's livelihoods under the guise of 'gender'." She called for immediate action, urging the Chief Minister to stop sitting in "AC rooms" and take real steps to address the ongoing liquor scam.

Sharmila's explosive comments have added further fuel to the political firestorm in Andhra Pradesh, as opposition parties continue to criticize the government's handling of key sectors, particularly liquor regulation.

Rapaka Varaprasad Likely to Quit YSR Congress...!

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former MLA of Rajolu, Rapaka Varaprasad, is set to bid farewell to the YSR Congress Party (YCP) after being sidelined following the Andhra Pradesh Assembly elections. Speaking to the media at his residence in Kathimanda, Varaprasad made it clear that he can no longer continue with YCP, citing personal grievances and the party's decision to overlook him for a ticket in the recent elections.

Varaprasad, who had previously been a key figure for YCP in Rajolu, expressed disappointment over not being given a ticket despite his hard work and loyalty. He pointed out that YCP handed the ticket to Gollapalli Surya Rao instead, which he took as an insult to his efforts. Though he contested for the MP seat on the advice of his seniors, Varaprasad confessed that it was against his personal wishes, leading to a further breakdown in his relationship with YCP.

In a significant political development, Varaprasad announced that he will soon join another party, though he did not reveal which one. However, there are widespread rumors



that he is trying to rejoin the Janasena Party, the platform from which he originally won as an MLA in 2019. Despite these reports, Varaprasad's potential return to Janasena is being met with strong opposition from party leaders and workers in the constituency.

In 2019, Rapaka won on a Janasena ticket but later switched to YCP after criticizing Janasena and its leader, Pawan Kalyan. At the time, he commented that Janasena lacked the

strength to make a significant impact, claiming that his victory was a result of favorable circumstances rather than the party's popularity. This shift left a sour impression among Janasena members, who now resist his re-entry.

The situation escalated when Varaprasad participated in a Janasena meeting in Malikipuram, sparking outrage among party workers who questioned how someone who once criticized Pawan Kalyan and the party could return. Rumors also surfaced that Varaprasad was in talks with key leaders to smooth his re-entry into Janasena, a move that was met with disapproval from local party members.

Janasena MLA Deva Vara Prasad responded to the controversy, stating that Rapaka had only attended the meeting to discuss matters related to college lecturers and that no political issues were raised. Nonetheless, Rapaka Varaprasad's political future remains a hot topic of discussion in Konaseema, as the dynamics of his potential comeback continue to

TPN, Vijayawada: Four Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers from the Andhra Pradesh cadre—Vakati Karuna, Vaniprasad, Amrapali, and Srijana—have filed a petition in the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) challenging the orders of the Department of Personnel and Training (D.O.P.T.).

The petitioners are seeking to quash the D.O.P.T. orders that affect their service conditions. Specifically, they are requesting that three of the IAS officers be permitted to continue their tenure in Telangana. Additionally, Srijana is seeking interim orders to allow her to remain in Andhra Pradesh.

This legal challenge comes amid ongoing discussions about the allocation of IAS officers between Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, highlighting the complexities of administrative service transfers in the region. The outcome of the petition will determine the future placements of these officers.

Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu Accuses YS Jagan of Diverting **Panchayat Funds**



TPN, Vijayawada: Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu has accused former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy of diverting panchayat funds, declaring him a traitor in the process. Speaking during a village festival program in Gorintada and surrounding areas of Palakollu mandal, Ramanaidu criticized Jagan's administration for allegedly undermining local governance.

The minister emphasized the coalition government's commitment to village development, noting that foundation stones were laid for various projects during the festival. He remarked, "Gandhi's dream of village swaraj is only possible with the NDA government." Ramanaidu highlighted the significant achievement of passing resolutions for development works in 13,326 panchayat gram sabhas in a single day.

The government is undertaking approximately 30,000 projects with an allocated budget of ₹4,500 crores during this village festival. Ramanaidu stated the aim is to complete 3,000 kilometers of cement roads in rural areas before Sankranthi. He criticized the previous administration for weakening panchayati raj institutions and stated that the diversion of panchayat funds occurred during Jagan's tenure, leaving sarpanchs and local governance in a state of distress.

Applications Are Opened Online and Offline For Free Sand - Minister Kollu Ravindra

108 New Sand Reaches Available

TPN, Vijayawada: Minister Kollu Ravindra announced the opening of 108 new sand reaches from the 16th of this month, emphasizing that 40 of these will be operational in the first phase to facilitate river upliftment. During a media conference addressing the state's sand policy, he criticized the previous government for complicating sand availability and questioned whether any such announcements had been made during their tenure.

Kollu Ravindra revealed that sand from patta lands will also be accessible at prices set by district committees. He assured that the cabinet would discuss and decide on the recognition of new sand reaches located in riverside areas. A free sand pol-



icvis expected to be implemented statewide within the next one to two months, with strict penalties for any violations of the regulations. He noted that 40 vehicles previously violating these rules have already been impounded.

Applications for sand can be submitted both online and offline. The minister explained that sand can be obtained from sand reaches using tractors and mentioned that a policy regarding robot sand will be formulated soon. He stated that since the coalition government took charge, all sand reserves have been brought under government control.

Kollu Ravindra also addressed concerns about an artificial shortage of sand, which is affecting tipper drivers, asserting that officials are creating this shortage. He criticized the previous government's liquor policy for corruption and confirmed that all aspects of liquor production and sales are now government-controlled.

Additionally, he emphasized that liquor shops will not be permitted within 100 meters of temples and schools, with firm actions to be taken against violators. The police system has reportedly been strengthened compared to the previous government, with severe penalties anticipated for operating illegal belt shops.

Allocation of 113 Liquor Stores in NTR District



TPN, Vijayawada: The allocation of 113 private liquor shops in NTR District has been completed with a high level of transparency, as confirmed by District Collector Dr. G. Srijana. The lottery process, part of the New Liquor Policy (2024-26), took place on Monday at NAC Kalyan Mandapam, Guru Nanak Colony, Vijayawada, under the auspices of the State Prohibition and Excise Department.



Regional Dynamics

Israel's primary goal is not to destroy Iran but to weaken its proxy network, including Hezbollah, Hamas, and the Houthis. These

groups hinder normalization ef- Strategic Outlook forts in the Middle East, where With interests in Chabahar port Indian interests are also at stake. The interconnectedness of these conflicts is further highlighted by Russia's backing of Iran's proxies, which aligns with its strategy of using groups like the Wagner Group for its interests.

SC Upholds **Scheduled Castes** Sub-Categorisation, **Rejects Reviews**

On October 4, the Supreme Court upheld the constitutional validity of sub-categorising Scheduled Castes, rejecting review petitions against its August 1 judgment. This landmark decision reflects significant shifts in the conversation around reservation, though it has faced strong criticism from prominent commentators who argue that it does not represent meaningful change.

The Court's earlier 2022 ruling on Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) reservations has been seen as a departure from its traditionally progressive stance on social justice, described as having "applied dynamite" to its jurisprudence. The recent sub-categorisation verdict seeks to restore some of the lost doctrinal integrity.

In a 6-1 majority ruling by a seven-judge constitutional bench, the Court has overruled its 2004 decision in *E V Chinnaiah vs. State of Andhra Pradesh*, which had previously deemed sub-categorisation unconstitutional. This ruling also invalidated the Andhra Pradesh "Rationalisation of Reservation" Act of 2000, which attempted to implement such a scheme.

The implications of this verdict extend beyond legal boundaries, influencing the socio-political landscape and the rights of marginalized communities. It reaffirms the necessity of nuanced approaches to reservation, aiming to address inequities within the Scheduled Castes. While the Court's ruling is seen as a step forward, ongoing debates and criticisms highlight the complexities surrounding reservations and their impact on social justice.

As the legal framework evolves, the focus now shifts to how this decision will shape future policies and the broader discourse on equality and representation in India.

India, as a founding BRICS member, must leverage this platform to advocate for its interests in global governance. The UN Security Council, a relic of the 20th century, does not reflect the current geopolitical realities, and India deserves a permanent voice in decisions affecting global peace and security. The Indian government seeks reforms in international financial institutions, emphasizing its desire for a more equitable global order.

The West, particularly the US, France, and the UK, have shown support for India's position but their intentions remain ambiguous amid the ongoing geopolitical tensions, especially with the Ukraine conflict. India must move beyond merely petitioning for recognition and instead use BRICS to amplify its voice.

President Droupadi Murmu announced on Sunday the withdrawal of President's rule in Jammu and Kashmir, clearing the way for a new government to be formed in the union territory. The Union Home Ministry issued a gazette notification confirming this decision.

The notification cited the revocation of the previous order from October 31, 2019, which imposed central rule following the bifurcation of the former state into two union territories: Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh. This change aligns with the powers granted under Section 73 of the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019, and Articles 239 and 239A of the Indian Constitution.

The recent Jammu and Kashmir Assembly elections saw the National Conference (NC) and Congress alliance emerge victorious, paving the way for the formation of a government. NC vice president Omar Abdullah has been designated as the new chief minister, having been elected as the leader of the alliance.


Central rule was first instituted in the region on October 31, 2019, coinciding with the

Former Maharashtra minister and NCP leader Baba Siddique was tragically shot dead outside his son's office on Saturday, prompting Chief Minister Eknath Shinde to vow that those responsible will face justice. "Our responsibility is to maintain law and order. Whoever is responsible for Baba Siddique's murder will not be spared," Shinde

The Chief Minister criticized the previous Maharashtra Vikas Aghadi (MVA) government for a perceived decline in law and order, claiming that security measures weakened during their administration, resulting in a rise in criminal activities. He assured the public that his government would deliver justice and hold lawbreakers account-

Siddique's murder has raised significant concerns about public safety across the state. In response, Mumbai Police arrested two suspects—one from Uttar Pradesh and the other from Haryana—while a third suspect remains at large. Shinde emphasized that efforts to apprehend the fugitive are being intensified. "They will not be spared, whether they belong to the Bishnoi gang or any other underworld group. Strict action will be taken," he affirmed.

Reports indicate that Siddique was shot multiple times, sustaining two critical gunshot wounds to his chest, and he was rushed to Lilavati Hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries shortly after arrival.

The incident has sparked a political outcry, with a heated exchange between the ruling BJP and opposition parties.

Kerala Assembly Calls for Withdrawal of **Controversial Waqf Amendment Bill**



On October 14, the Kerala Legislative Assembly unanimously passed a resolution urging the central government to withdraw the contentious 2024 Waqf Amendment Bill. Minister for Waqf, Haj pilgrimage, and sports, V Abdurahiman, introduced the resolution, arguing that the bill undermines federal principles outlined in the Constitution.

Abdurahiman contended that the bill infringes on state rights concerning Waqf matters, effectively diminishing the authority of Waqf boards and tribunals responsible for overseeing Waqf properties. He asserted, "This bill not only violates the secular principles enshrined in the Constitution but also jeopardizes democratic values by replacing elected representatives with a board of nominated members and a nominated chairman."

The minister emphasized that fundamental rights, such as freedom of belief, secularism, and democracy, should not be compromised. He highlighted that certain provisions in the bill contradict the very essence of the Constitution and called for its immediate withdrawal by the central government.

The resolution received support from the opposition Congress-led United Democratic Front (UDF), which proposed several amendments during the discussions, some of which were accepted. This bipartisan agreement illustrates the assembly's collective opposition to the proposed bill, reflecting broader concerns about federal overreach and the safeguarding of democratic processes within state governance.





India's Factory Output Contracts for First Time in 21 Months

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India's factory output, measured by the Index of Industrial Production (IIP), experienced a contraction of 0.1% in August 2023, marking the first decline in 21 months. This downturn is attributed to a high base effect and a drop in mining and electricity production, according to data released by the National Statistical

Office (NSO).

In the preceding months, industrial output had shown robust growth, with increases of 4.7% in July and 10.9% in August. However, the contraction in August suggests a shift in the industrial landscape. Cumulatively, during the financial year 2024-25, industrial growth has been recorded at 4.2% for the period of April to August, compared to 6.2% during the same timeframe in the previous financial year.

The decline raises concerns about the sustainability of industrial growth in India, especially amid fluctuating global economic conditions. Analysts suggest that the high base effect from the previous year, when industrial output was notably strong, is impacting current figures. ICICI Securities' Minority Shareholder Accuses Sebi of Collusion on Delisting

Quantum Mutual Fund, a minority shareholder of ICI-CI Securities, has raised serious allegations against the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) in a case concerning the company's delisting. During a hearing at the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT), the fund claimed that Sebi was "hand in glove" with ICICI Securities regarding the delisting process.

The NCLAT bench, comprising Justices Yogesh Khanna and Ajai Das Mehrotra, was reviewing an appeal from Quantum Mutual Fund, which holds just 0.002% of ICICI Securities' paid-up equity share capital, along with Manu Rishi Guptha, who owns 0.08%. They are contesting a recent ruling from the Ahmedabad bench of the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) that approved the delisting plan and dismissed the shareholders' objections.

The controversy centers around a letter from Sebi dated June 23, which allowed ICICI Bank some leeway under Regulation 37 of Sebi's Delisting Regulations. This exemption permits the delisting of ICICI Securities despite the parent and subsidiary companies not operating in the same line of business, as typically required.

Arun Kathpalia, the senior counsel for ICICI Securities, refuted these claims, asserting that the Sebi letter could not be contested in the NCLT or NCLAT. He emphasized the severity of the accusations directed at the market regulator.

The NCLAT has scheduled a follow-up hearing for Tuesday, where ICICI Securities will continue to present its case. The outcome of this appeal could have significant implications for the regulatory landscape and the relationship between minority shareholders and corporate governance in India.

India's Wholesale Inflation Rises to 1.84% Amid Higher Food Prices



India's wholesale inflation rose to 1.84% in September, up from a four-month low of 1.31% in August, driven primarily by increasing food prices, according to data released by the government on October 14. The wholesale price index (WPI) showed a slight contraction of -0.1% in September 2023.

Since April, wholesale prices have remained above 1%, with the average inflation for FY24 recorded at -0.7%. During this period, the country experienced deflation in seven out of the twelve months. Economists now project wholesale inflation to average between 2% and 3% for

The recent rise in inflation is influenced by a favorable base effect, despite subdued commodity prices largely due to weak demand from China. As food prices continue to fluctuate, market analysts will be closely monitoring the factors contributing to inflation trends in the coming months, as well as the broader economic implications for India.





India slams Canada's move targeting Indian diplomats

regarding its High Commissioner being a "person of interest" in the murder investigation of Hardeep Singh Nijjar, labeling these allegations as "preposterous." The Ministry of External Affairs issued a statement accusing Canada of failing to provide evidence to support its claims and suggested that the Trudeau government is exploiting the situation for electoral gain by catering to pro-Khalistani sentiments within Canada.

The statement emphasized that Verma is a highly regarded diplomat with a distinguished career spanning 36 years, and that the accusations against him deserve

India has firmly rebutted Canada's claims to be treated with contempt. India highlighted that Canada has not shared any evidence despite multiple requests since the initial allegations were made.

Trump Should Do The Same: Kamala Harris After Releasing **Medical Report**



Democratic presidential nominee Kamala Harris has called on her Republican rival Donald Trump to release his medical records, emphasizing the importance of transparency in health and policy matters. This request came a day after Harris's own medical report confirmed she is in "excellent health" and fit for the presidency.

"Yesterday, I released my medical records. Donald Trump should do the same," Harris stated on X, urging voters to scrutinize Trump's transparency regarding his health. In a video accompanying her tweet, she invited the public to observe Trump's rally performances as a gauge of his mental acuity.

During a rally in North Carolina, Harris highlighted the age gap between her and Trump, who is 78 years old. She criticized Trump for not releasing his medical information and for declining to participate in a second debate, suggesting that his team might be trying to shield him from scrutiny.

"Why does his staff want him to hide away? Are they afraid that people will see he is too weak and unstable to lead America?" she questioned, emphasizing the need for voters to have access to critical information before making electoral decisions.

Harris's recent medical report describes her as a "healthy 59-year-old female" with only minor seasonal allergies. In contrast, Trump's medical history remains largely undisclosed, though his campaign recently released a letter confirming he is in "excellent" health, with normal physical exams and "exceptional" cognitive test results.

Harris is focusing on North Carolina, a key battleground state that hasn't voted for a Democratic nominee since Barack Obama in 2008. Polls indicate it is a tossup, making a Democratic win crucial for Trump's path to the necessary 270 electoral votes.

Ukraine Destroys Russian Military Transport Plane

Kyiv announced on Monday that its forces destroyed a Russian military transport plane located at a military airfield deep within Russian territory over the weekend. This claim marks a significant escalation in Ukraine's efforts to target Russian military assets behind enemy lines.

Ukraine's military intelligence agency reported that the Tu-134 transport aircraft was destroyed overnight between Saturday and Sunday in the Orenburg region, approximately 1,000 kilometers (620 miles) from the Ukrainian border. The agency stated that these Soviet-era planes are primarily used to transport high-ranking officials from the Russian defense ministry.

Accompanying the announcement, the agency shared footage purportedly showing an arson attack on the aircraft, with flames visible, although details on how the operation was executed were not disclosed.

As of now, there has been no official response from Moscow regarding the claims made by Ukraine. Since



the onset of Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, the Kremlin has detained numerous individuals accused of sabotage and arson aimed at military and civilian infrastructure.

In recent months, Ukraine has intensified its attacks within Russian territory, focusing on military installations and energy facilities. These actions aim to disrupt Russian military logistics and supply

chains, reflecting a strategic shift in Ukraine's approach to the ongoing conflict.

The incident underscores the ongoing volatility of the situation and highlights Ukraine's commitment to retaliating against Russian military operations. As the conflict continues, both sides remain on high alert, with potential repercussions for military strategies and diplomatic relations.

France Plans New Immigration Law Amid Right-Wing Push

French authorities are set to introduce a new immigration law next year as the right-wing government seeks to tighten immigration policies and border controls. Government spokeswoman Maud Bregeon confirmed the plans during an interview with BFMTV on Sunday, emphasizing the need for a comprehensive legislative approach.

The proposed bill, expected to be presented to parliament in early 2025, reflects the political shift following this summer's legislative elections, which resulted in a hung parliament. The urgency for reform has been underscored by recent incidents, including the tragic rape and murder of a Paris student, allegedly by a Moroccan suspect, sparking intense public debate over immigration and security.

One of the key features of the new legislation would be extending the detention period for undocumented migrants deemed dangerous.

Netanyahu considers 'surrender or starve' plan for northern Gaza

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu announced on Sunday that military operations are escalating in Jabalia, northern Gaza. The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) are urging civilians to evacuate south, as reports emerge of a contentious strategy aimed at cutting off humanitarian aid to the region. This plan, aimed at weakening Hamas, risks trapping hundreds of thousands of Palestinians without access to food or water.

Dubbed the "Generals' Plan," this proposal, created by a group of retired generals and revealed to the Associated Press, suggests giving residents of northern Gaza, including Gaza City, a week to evacuate before designating the area a closed military



zone. Those who do not leave would be treated as combatants, subject to military regulations allowing for lethal action against them, and would be denied essential supplies.

Giora Eiland, a former head of Israel's National Security Council and the plan's architect, argues that this strategy is crucial for disman-

tling Hamas leadership and pushing for the release of Israeli hostages. He outlined that the estimated 300,000 residents still in northern Gaza would have ten days to evacuate through safe corridors provided by Israel. After that, the area would become a military zone, leaving remaining individuals with the options to surrender or face starvation.

Despite the detailed nature of the plan, it remains uncertain whether the Israeli government will formally adopt it. An Israeli military spokesperson denied any connection between current evacuation orders and the Generals' Plan, while other officials indicated that some aspects might already be in effect.

Eating too much sugar may increase your risk of depression



Diet and nutrition significantly influence human health, and recent research reveals that a preference for sugary foods may lead to more than just weight gain. A study from the University of Surrey has established a strong connection between a love for sweets and serious health risks, including depression.

The study, published in the *Journal of Translational Medicine*, utilized data from the UK Biobank to examine the eating habits of participants categorized as health-conscious, omnivores, and sweet tooth individuals. Those with a sweet tooth favored sugary treats, cakes, and soft drinks while showing less interest in healthier options

like fruits and vegetables.

Key findings indicated that individuals with a sweet tooth faced a 31% higher risk of developing depression compared to their health-conscious counterparts. The researchers measured blood samples to analyze 2,923 proteins and 168 metabolites, discovering that the sweet tooth group exhibited poorer blood markers for inflammation and glucose levels. These markers are associated with increased risks for both metabolic and mental health conditions.

In contrast, the health-conscious group, who prioritized fruits and vegetables, demonstrated reduced risks for heart disease and stroke. The study underscores how food preferences play a crucial role in long-term health outcomes, emphasizing the importance of moderating sugar

These findings serve as a wake-up call regarding dietary choices and their long-term implications. By recognizing the potential health risks associated with a sweet tooth, individuals can take proactive steps toward improving their well-being. This research reinforces the idea that our food choices directly impact our overall health, urging us all to be mindful of what we consume for better health outcomes.



Apple Smart Glasses and AirPods with Cameras Set to Launch in 2027

Apple unveiled its first mixed-reality headset, Vision Pro, at the Worldwide Developers Conference (WWDC) last year. With over a year since its announcement and six months since shipping, the tech giant is reportedly developing additional products utilizing Vision Pro's advanced technology to compete with Meta.

According to Bloomberg's Mark Gurman, Apple's Vision Products Group is actively working on at least four new devices. Among these is a potential launch of smart glasses in 2027, designed to rival Meta's Ray-Ban smart glasses. Additionally, there are plans for a new pair of Air-Pods featuring integrated cameras.

Gurman highlights that Apple aims to leverage the billions invested in Vision Pro's visual intelligence technology by integrating its environmental detection capabilities into more products. This approach is part of a broader strategy to enhance user experiences across various de-

In terms of pricing strategy, Apple is preparing to release a lower-end version of the Vision headset as early as next year, expected to retail around \$2,000 (approximately Rs. 1,68,000). This model will utilize a less powerful processor and feature cost-effective materials, unlike the original Vision Pro, which starts at \$3,499 (about Rs. 2,90,000) and offers various storage options of 256GB, 512GB, and 1TB. The more affordable headset will notably exclude the EyeSight feature, which enhances user interaction.



Apple anticipates that the lower-priced model will significantly boost sales, potentially doubling the unit sales compared to the Vision Pro. Furthermore, a second-generation Vision Pro with improved performance is expected to launch in

The original Vision Pro, announced in June 2023, operates on visionOS and supports both augmented reality (AR) and virtual reality (VR) technologies. Currently available in markets like the US, China, Europe, and Japan, the headset is powered by Apple's M2 processor and an R1 chip, setting the stage for an exciting evolution in mixed-reality technology.

Adults Suspect Undiagnosed ADHD Due To Social Media Influence

A recent study highlights a growing awareness of attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) among adults in America, revealing that 25% of respondents suspect they may have the condition but remain undiagnosed. The national survey, which involved 1,000 American adults, indicates that social media videos are playing a significant role in helping individuals connect their struggles with attention, focus, and restlessness to ADHD.

Despite this increased awareness, only 13% of those who suspect they have ADHD have discussed their concerns with a healthcare provider. This raises alarm about the potential risks associated with self-diagnosis, as incorrect treatment could exacerbate underlying issues. Psychologist Justin Barterian from Ohio State University's Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Health warns that symptoms of anxiety, depression, and ADHD can be similar, and misdiagnosis may lead to ineffective or harmful treatments.

Barterian notes that approximately 4.4% of adults aged 18 to 44 are diagnosed with ADHD, and many individuals do not receive a diagnosis until later in life. Increased awareness about how ADHD can persist into adulthood has led many to recognize their own symptoms, especially when they see similar behaviors in their diagnosed children, given the genetic nature of the disorder.



Interestingly, the study found that younger adults are more likely than older generations to believe they might have undiagnosed ADHD. While social media can effectively raise awareness and educate individuals about ADHD, Barterian emphasizes the importance of seeking professional help for accurate diagnosis and treatment. Consulting with psychologists, psychiatrists, or physicians is essential for addressing concerns about ADHD and ensuring that individuals receive appropriate care tailored to their needs.

As conversations around mental health continue to evolve, understanding ADHD in adults is crucial for fostering informed and effective treatment pathways.






