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AP Cabinet Meeting Today, Decisions on Six New Policies Expected

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh meeting, chaired by Chief Min-Chandrababu Naidu, is set to convene today at the state secretariat, where six new policies are expected to be discussed. This meeting represents a crucial opportunity for the coalition government to finalize key initiatives aimed at bolstering the state's industrial sector and creating employment opportunities.



The proposed policies are designed to fulfill the government's election promise of generating 20 lakh jobs over the next five years and attracting significant investments. Officials have been working diligently on these policies for the past three months, conducting extensive exercises to ensure their viability and effectiveness. A comprehensive strategy has already been developed across approximately ten departments.

In recent weeks, CM Chandrababu has conducted a series of reviews, providing direction to officials regarding the

formulation of these policies. The primary focus of these new initiatives is to enhance the speed of business operations while prioritizing job creation.

Today's Cabinet meeting will address several critical areas, including policies related to industrial development, micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), electronics, clean energy, private industrial parks, and food processing. The outcomes of this meeting are anticipated to have a significant impact on the state's economic landscape and employment rates moving forward.

AP DGP Responds to Interception of Sajjala Ramakrishna Reddy at Delhi Airport

TPN. Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh Directorate General of Police (DGP), Dwaraka Tirumala Rao, has addressed the recent interception of former government advisor Sajjala Ramakrishna Reddy at Delhi airport, where he was stopped due to lookout notices issued against him. This incident highlights the ongoing legal troubles facing leaders of the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) since the coalition government took power in Andhra Pradesh.

Sajjala, a key figure in the previous government, encountered unexpected scrutiny from police at the airport. The DGP clarified that the action taken was a result of lookout notices issued by the Guntur Superintendent of In addition to addressing Sajjala's Police. He indicated that authorities were concerned about the potential

He announced that IG Tripathi and DIG Gopinath would represent the AP government in the SIT. The DGP emphasized that the SIT would operate as an independent investigative agency, ensuring thorough and impartial inquiries involving state police personnel.



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra tiatives for drug control and rehabili-Pradesh government has recently introduced a new liquor policy that includes a lottery system for the allocation of licenses for new liquor shops. This policy aims to streamline the process and reduce corruption in the liquor licensing system. However, it has sparked controversy, particularly regarding the tenders awarded to the new liquor shop owners.

Reports indicate that individuals who received tenders for these new liquor shops are now receiving warning calls from higher authorities within the government. These calls appear to be related to concerns over the legitimacy of the lottery system and allegations of favoritism in the tendering process. The situation has raised eyebrows among political leaders and the public, leading to suspicions about the transparency of the new policy.

Critics of the policy are questioning whether the lottery system is being manipulated and whether the government is favoring certain individuals or groups in the allocation of liquor licenses. As tensions rise, the Andhra Pradesh government is under increasing pressure to address these allegations and ensure a fair and transparent process for all stakeholders involved in the liquor

The Andhra Pradesh government has implemented a new liquor policy that includes a 2% cess on liquor sales, aimed at funding drug control and rehabilitation centers. This announcement comes as the state prepares to open new private wine shops today, following the closure of government-operated liquor stores that have been in operation for the past five years.

The government has revealed that the revenue generated from the newly imposed cess will be directed towards initation. Alongside this, the government has made amendments to address retail pricing issues in liquor purchases. Under the new policy, an additional privilege fee of Rs. 10 will be applied to the Maximum Retail Price (MRP) of liquor. For instance, if the MRP of a bottle of liquor is Rs. 150.50, it will now be priced at Rs. 160 to simplify retail adjustments.

As part of the new excise policy introduced by the coalition government, a total of 3,396 liquor shops have been allocated through a lottery system. The owners of these new shops are set to open their doors at 10 AM today, marking a significant shift in the state's liquor distribution landscape. The new private wine shops will operate daily from 10 AM to 10 PM.

In addition to the developments within Andhra Pradesh, applications for liquor shop licenses have also been received online from neighboring states including Telangana, Karnataka, Delhi, Maharashtra, and Uttar Pradesh. Furthermore, there have been applications from international locations, including the United States and other countries.

Despite the government's attempts to streamline liquor sales and generate revenue for social initiatives, the new policy has sparked controversy. Critics are raising concerns over the transparency of the lottery system used for allocating licenses, as many individuals who received tenders for new liquor shops have reported receiving warning calls from higher authorities. This has led to suspicions about potential favoritism and manipulation within the allocation process.

As tensions rise, the Andhra Pradesh government is under increasing pressure to ensure a fair and transparent implementation of its new liquor policy.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The gold business in Tadepalligudem is taking a controversial turn, with some merchants allegedly using investment schemes as bait to cheat customers. Many jewelry merchants in the area are running schemes alongside their

regular business operations, in which they collect monthly installments from people, promising to deliver gold equivalent to the amount paid after one year. These merchants assure customers that they will receive gold at the rate on the dispatch date and claim it will be 916 KDM quality.

However, in Tadepalligudem, reports suggest that some gold merchants, including Pavan



Kala Jewellers, have collected significant sums under these schemes—amounting to over ₹8 crores—and are now allegedly planning to declare insolvency (IP) to escape their obligations. If these merchants declare insolvency, they are not required to repay the customers or provide gold, effectively walking away with the funds.



CAT Rejects Interim Orders on IAS Officers' Plea Against DoPT Transfers

TPN. Andhra Pradesh: In a recent development, the Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) has declined to issue interim orders on petitions filed by several IAS officers, including Amrapali, Vakati Karuna, Vani Prasad, and Srijana, who challenged the transfer orders issued by the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT). The IAS officers, who had been transferred to their home state cadres, approached CAT seeking to continue in their current postings.

DoPT had instructed Amrapali, Vani Prasad, and Vakati Karuna, who were assigned to Andhra Pradesh but currently serving in Telangana, and Srijana, who was assigned to Telangana but serving in Andhra Pradesh, to return to their respective state cadres. However, the officers filed petitions with CAT challenging these orders and sought interim relief to continue in their current positions.

During the hearing, the advocates representing the IAS officers argued that the DoPT had issued these instructions based on the recommendations of a single-member committee, but the report was not shared with the officers. They also contended that the authority to allocate IAS officers lies with DoPT, and questioned how the department could act on the committee's recommendations without proper communication.

CAT made noteworthy comments during the hearing, pointing out the critical need for IAS officers to serve in Andhra Pradesh, which is currently facing challenges due to floods. The tribunal questioned why the officers had not responded to the committee's appointment earlier or filed a contempt petition. In light of these observations, CAT refused to grant interim orders on the petitions, stating that the DoPT's transfer orders would remain in effect.

This ruling underscores the DoPT's authority in transferring IAS officers and highlights the ongoing administrative reshuffling between Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

Storm Expected in Bay of Bengal in Next 24 Hours TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Indian Meteoro-

logical Department (IMD) has reported that a low-pressure system over the south-central Bay of Bengal has intensified and is expected to further strengthen into a cyclone within the next 24 hours. The IMD's Amaravati Division indicated that the system is moving west-northwest and will enter the southwest Bay of Bengal soon.

The cyclone is projected to head towards the coasts of North Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, and South Andhra Pradesh. Surface circulation is also developing, which is expected to result in heavy to very heavy rainfall across Andhra Pradesh for the next three days.

The IMD also announced that the Southwest Monsoon has fully withdrawn from the country as of today, and the Northeast Monsoon has



officially commenced. Heavy rains associated with the system are expected to hit the region shortly, urging residents to stay cautious and prepared.

Granthi Vishwanath Met DCM Pawan Kalyan Regarding Movie Ticket Prices

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Grandhi Vishwanath, MD of Poorna Pictures and former president of the Andhra Pradesh Film Chamber, has urged the state government to introduce a flexible pricing policy for movie tickets. During a meeting with Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan on Tuesday, Vishwanath highlighted the challenges the Telugu film industry is facing due to the rising influence of OTT platforms and rigid movie ticket pricing.

Vishwanath emphasized that a flexible ticket pricing policy, similar to those in states like Telangana, Maharashtra, and Karnataka, could benefit the film industry. He noted that high ticket prices discourage the public, especially lower-income groups, from visiting cinemas. According to him, introducing minimum and maximum ticket rates, based on the scale and production value of the film, would attract more viewers and help small and medium-budget films thrive.

During the meeting, Vishwanath presented a souvenir copy of *Shata Vasantala* to Pawan Kalyan and explained how the flexible rate system could revive interest in cinema. He stated,

"This approach is beneficial for all levels of films, bringing audiences back to theaters."

Pawan Kalyan responded positively to Vishwa-





nath's suggestions and assured that he would bring the matter to the attention of the Chief Minister, raising hopes for potential changes in the state's film industry policies.

Describing the event as "very sad," the Minister emphasized the swift action taken by law enforcement, with the accused apprehended within 48 hours using advanced technology.

Among the arrested, three in- en do not escape justice. dividuals are minors, while another has a troubling history with 32 prior cases against him. Minister Anita confirmed that the case would be forwarded to a special court to expedite the judicial process, assuring the public that the perpetrators would be punished swiftly. She stressed that the government is committed to ensuring that those who commit crimes against wom-

Key Development in AP Skill Development Case

ED Attaches Assets Worth ₹23.54 Crore

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a significant development in the Andhra Pradesh Skill Development case, the Enforcement Directorate (ED) has attached assets worth ₹23.54 crore. These assets belong to Siemens and are located in major cities including Delhi, Mumbai, and Pune. The attached properties consist of both fixed and movable assets.

The ED's investigation into the case was based on a prior inquiry by the AP CID. The probe revealed that funds meant for skill development were diverted to personal accounts through the

use of fake invoices. Assets belonging to key individuals in the case, such as DTCL MD Khanwilkar, former Siemens MD Suman Bose, and Mukul Chand, have also been attached.

This case is also notable for the earlier arrest of Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, who spent 53 days in jail following his detention by the CID. The investigation into the skill development scheme continues, with further legal actions expected in the coming weeks.






Somireddy Criticizes Jagan for Earning Crores Through Liquor Sales

I'll Not Contest if Elections Are Held Through EVM'S

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former MLA Rachamallu Sivaprasad Reddy has made a bold statement, declaring that he will not contest in the 2029 elections if they are conducted through Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs). Reddy echoed the concerns of YCP chief Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, who recently expressed distrust in EVMs, calling for elections to be conducted using traditional ballot papers for fair and transparent results.

Rachamallu claimed that fraud is prevalent in elections conducted via EVMs, suggesting that the outcomes can be manipulated, much like what he believes happened in previous elections. He stated that clean and authentic results can only be achieved through the use of ballot papers, urging that the system return to this method for the sake of democracy.

The former MLA went on to allege that the verdict in recent elections was not delivered by the people, but by EVMs, implying that the results were tampered with. He pointed out that suspicions regarding the integrity of EVMs arose immediately after vote counting, with many people questioning the results. Despite these doubts, he criticized the Election Commission for not addressing public con-



Reddy has now called on the Supreme Court to intervene and examine the issue of EVMs, stressing that democratic principles are at risk if the same technology is used in future elections. He warned that if EVMs are used again, the outcome of elections would be predetermined, and leaders would be chosen undemocratically through the misuse of technology.

This strong stance against EVMs reflects growing concerns within the YCP about the integrity of the election process and raises important questions about the future of electoral practices in India.

Jamili Elections Are Coming Soon - Kakani

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: YCP leader and former minister Kakani Govardhan Reddy made critical remarks about the TDP and its policies, particularly in relation to the possibility of Jamili elections in 2027. He stated that if Jamili elections are held, the TDP government would only last for two years, highlighting a short tenure for the party. Kakani also issued a warning to officials, advising them not to act on the directions of TDP leaders, suggesting that those who do may face consequences in the future.

Kakani accused TDP leaders of controlling 90 percent of the newly opened liquor shops, claiming the lottery system for shop allocation was pre-planned and rigged to benefit them. He alleged that the process was conducted under



the supervision of ministers and MLAs, further accusing TDP chief Chandrababu Naidu of creating a liquor policy solely to benefit the "yellow batch," referring to TDP's party colors.

The former minister went on to criticize the state's liquor industry, claiming that distilleries are under TDP control and that the li-

quor sold is of inferior quality. He warned that belt shops (unauthorized liquor outlets) would proliferate across the state, and suggested that the delivery of liquor to homes might become common practice.

Kakani also accused Chandrababu of planning a three-tier system for the allotment of liquor shops, with the TDP chief overseeing the process at the state level, MLAs managing allocations at the constituency level, and local leaders controlling belt shops at the village level, allowing for widespread corruption in the liquor business.

These comments have sparked heated political debate, with Kakani emphasizing the negative impact of TDP's policies on the state and its governance.

Will Rapaka Varaprasad Join TDP?

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: After the YSR Congress Party's defeat in the recent assembly elections, a wave of resignations from party leaders has been observed, with senior figures parting ways with the YCP. Among them is former MLA Rapaka Varaprasad, who recently resigned from the party, fueling speculation about his next political move. Rapaka Varaprasad was the only Janasena MLA to win in the 2019 elections, representing the Rajole constituency.

Following his victory, Rapaka grew close to the ruling YCP, distancing himself from Janasena and even criticizing its leader, Pawan Kalyan. However, in the recent elections, Rapaka, who contested as an MP from Amalapuram under the YCP

banner, faced defeat. Since then, he has been staying away from YCP activities. After the loss, he openly criticized YCP leaders for blaming EVMs and emphasized that the people simply did not vote for the YCP.

Rapaka's resignation from the YCP was expected, especially after expressing his dissatisfaction with the party for not granting him a ticket for the Rajolu constituency. He voiced his frustration, saying that despite his dedication and hard work, YCP ignored him and gave the ticket to Gollapalli Surya Rao. Rapaka also revealed that he contested for the Amalapuram MP seat on the advice of elders, even though he was reluctant.

Amid this fallout, there are rumors of Rapaka attempting to return to Janasena, but his re-entry is facing opposition from both party leadership and grassroots workers. Additionally, reports suggest that Rapaka has had discussions with district-level leaders, but joining the TDP remains uncertain due to its alliance with Janasena.

Rapaka, a two-time MLA, having previously won from Congress in 2009 and Janasena in 2019, now finds himself at a political crossroads. If given the green light from the TDP leadership, it appears likely that he will don the yellow scarf and join the party. Minister Nadendla Manohar Seizes 100 Tons of Illegal Stored Ration Rice in N.T.R. Dist



TPN, Vijayawada: In a significant volving ration rice, Minister Nadendcrackdown on illegal activities in- la Manohar conducted a surprise in-

spection at Sri Lakshmi Ganapati Rice Mill near Paritala village in Kanchikacharla Mandal of N.T.R. district on Tuesday. During the inspection, the Minister uncovered the illegal storage of 100 tons of ration rice, meant for distribution under government schemes aimed at providing food security for the poor.

Officials, acting on intelligence, discovered large quantities of ration rice bags hidden within the mill. The investigation revealed that the rice, distributed under central and state government schemes, was being diverted by the mill management. Instead of reaching the intended beneficiaries, the rice was being purchased from ration cardholders, mixed with high-quality Sambamasuri rice, and sold at a higher price to earn illegal

Minister Nadendla Manohar expressed his concern over the misuse of ration rice, which is meant to benefit the poor, and vowed to take strict action against those involved. "It is unfortunate that food meant for the underprivileged is being turned into a business commodity by illegal traders," he said. The minister further emphasized that the government would not tolerate such activities and is committed to ensuring that

the food security system works as intended.

The seized rice, along with a lorry used in the transportation of the illegally stored sacks, has been confiscated by authorities. This action is part of a larger initiative to curb the widespread smuggling and misuse of government-provided ration rice.

Minister Nadendla's firm stance on the issue has sent a strong message that illegal practices surrounding food security schemes will not be allowed to continue unchecked. Further investigations are ongoing, and strict legal action will be taken against those responsible.

Water Quality Testing Underway in Gudivada Constituency





TPN, Gudivada: Under the directives of Deputy Chief Minister Shri Pawan Kalyan, water quality tests have been initiated in Gudivada constituency following complaints of discolored and potentially unsafe drinking water in 44 residential areas. During the recent "Village Festival" program, MLA Shri Venigandla Ramu presented samples of discolored water from Gudivada, Nandiwada, and Gudlavalleru mandals, prompting immediate action from the The collected samples were sent to lab-Deputy Chief Minister.

Concerns Rise Over Women Police Safety in **Machavaram Station**

TPN, Vijayawada: A disturbing incident at the Machavaram police station has raised serious concerns regarding the lack of protection for women police officers within the Police Commissionerate. A female constable, identified as Bhavani, who was on operational duty at the Vijayawada Government Hospital, attempted suicide following alleged harassment by her superior.

Reports indicate that during a recent roll call, Machavaram Circle Inspector (CI) Prakash verbally abused Bhavani in front of her colleagues. This incident, which included sarcastic remarks, left Bhavani feeling humiliated and distressed. Following the altercation, she reportedly swallowed sleeping pills in an attempt to take her own life. Relatives quickly rushed her to the hospital, where she is receiving treatment for her suicide attempt.

This is not an isolated case; a similar incident occurred in the same police station previously, where another female constable faced harassment, leading to attempts on her life. The continuous harassment of women staff at the Machavaram police station has raised alarms about their safety and well-being in a work environment that should prioritize their protection.

The incident highlights the urgent need for systemic changes within the police department to ensure the safety and dignity of female officers. Advocacy for stronger protective measures and accountability for those in positions of authority is essential to prevent



Vijayawada Municipal Corporation Launches Loan Facility Pilot Project



TPN, Vijayawada: The Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) has launched a pilot project to provide loan facilities to six categories of Common Interest Groups (CIGs) under the National Urban Livelihood Mission 2.0. The initiative, selected for Vijayawada and Visakhapatnam, aims to improve access to loans for groups working in various sectors.

In a meeting held on Tuesday at the VMC's main office, Commissioner Dhyana Chandra emphasized the need for coordination between bankers and Urban Community Development (UCD) staff to streamline the loan process. He instructed UCD staff to form CIGs, similar to Self-Help Groups, specifically for workers in transport, construction, domestic services, waste management, and care sectors. The Commissioner also urged bankers to collaborate in providing loans to these groups.

Furthermore, the Commissioner directed the 19 bank coordinators present to ex-

pedite the sanctioning of loans under the National Urban Livelihood Mission and the Prime Minister's Swanidhi Scheme. The focus is on clearing pending loans for the 4,808 street vendors in the city, ensuring they receive their first, second, and third tranche loans based on eligibility.

To ensure smooth implementation, the Commissioner ordered field staff, including RPs, COs, social workers, CDOs, and bank coordinators, to work closely to provide beneficiaries with the required loan facilities.

Lead District Manager Priyanka, UCD Project Officer Venkateshwaralu, and other UCD and MEPM staff attended the meeting, along with the 19 bank coordinators.

Removing Stones, Cultivating Futures, Tribal Farmers in Meliyaputti Embrace Rice **Farming**



TPN, Srikakulam: In the hilly regions of Meliyaputti mandal, tribal villages such as Kerashingi, Guda, and Chandanagiri have long faced challenges in farming due to rocky terrain. Traditionally, farmers cultivated paddy along with cashew, millet, and sorghum, but financial hardships arose from limited forest products and difficult farming conditions.

Recently, some farmers have taken the initiative to transform wastelands into productive agricultural land. Using bulldozers to remove stones, they have flattened the terrain for cultivation. Lacking oxen for plowing, they dig the soil with sharp shovels to create suitable furrows for planting rice. Agricultural officials report that this year, 54 farmers in Kerashingi alone have cultivated rice across 70 acres, contributing to an estimated total of 5,000 acres in hilly villages.

However, these efforts have been hindered by the previous government's policies. Under the TDP government, funding for tribal development was provided through the Integrated Tribal Development Agency (ITDA), which included subsidies for farmers. Unfortunately, after the YCP government took office, funding was halted, and essential projects like the construction and repair of check dams were neglected. This led to many farmers abandoning rice cultivation due to a lack of irrigation.

With the new coalition government in power, there is renewed hope. Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan's announcement to link employment funds to agriculture has sparked optimism for improved irrigation.

Savara Ramaiah, a farmer from Kerashingi, noted, "With the coalition government, we finally have hope for irrigation water." Meanwhile, Shanmukha Rao, a Village Agricultural Assistant, highlighted the fertile soil's potential, saying, "We are committed to assisting tribal farmers through subsidies." As these farmers adapt, a brighter agricultural future is emerging in Meliyaputti.

move to improve the quality of meals served to government school students, the coalition government has announced plans to revamp the Dokka Seethamma Midday Meal Scheme ahead of Diwali. The initiative comes as a response to the poor quality of food provided under the previous YSP regime, which included items like rotten eggs, tasteless ragijava, and worm-infested chickpeas. Many students found the meals inedible and often brought food from home.

Recognizing the need for change, Education Minister Nara Lokesh ordered

The government plans to provide a balanced combination of proteins and carbohydrates and will invest approximately ₹12 crores monthly to cater to around 179,000 students across 1,915 primary schools, 315 UP schools, and 419 high schools, Some proposals from parents and educators include:

Grand Celebrations for Piditalli Ammavari Sirimanu

TPN, Vizianagaram: The Piditalli Ammavari Sirimanu celebrations commenced with great enthusiasm in Jayanagaram, marking the first anniversary of Paidithalli Amma. The festivities are set to reach a peak with the Rathotsavam, scheduled to begin at 3 PM on Tuesday. The district administration has made elaborate arrangements, including a detailed security plan involving 2,000 police personnel to ensure the safety of the large crowds expected to attend.

Tragic Incident in Chittoor District: Farmer Killed by Elephants

TPN, Chittor: In a shocking incident concern among the local population, as in Chittoor district, the movement of elephants has escalated, resulting in tragic consequences for local farmers. Areas such as Devalampet, Ayyavandlapalle, and Errapapireddypalle have reported increased elephant activity, with herds often attacking crops and leaving destruction in their wake.

The situation reached a critical point in Pileru, within the Punganur constituency, where a farmer, identified as Raja Reddy, was brutally killed by a herd of elephants. This group, comprising around 15 elephants, had been roaming the area for several days, wreaking havoc on crops and instilling fear among the farming community. When Raja Reddy attempted to protect his mango grove from the rampaging elephants, he was tragically trampled and buried beneath the soil.

This incident has sparked outrage and

farmers continue to suffer the consequences of these elephant incursions. In response, forest officials have been alerted and are working diligently to assess the situation and relocate the elephants back to their forest habitat.

The Andhra Pradesh government has already implemented measures to safeguard farmers and their crops from elephant-related damages across several districts, including Chittoor, Manyam, Vizianagaram, and Parvathipuram. Recently, Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan signed a significant agreement with the Karnataka government to address these issues. Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah has responded positively, and the agreement includes key initiatives such as training mahouts, transferring kunki elephants to Andhra Pradesh, and maintaining elephant camps to manage the situation more effectively.



The Legacy of Sai Baba: A Life of Resilience and Resistance

Shortly after his release from prison, following the Nagpur bench of the Bombay High Court's judgment, Sai called to meet. I found him unexpectedly resolute and focused. He inquired about the possibility of reclaiming his job as an assistant professor at Delhi University. I suggested he take time to recover first, but he believed returning to teaching could aid his healing and address his family's financial struggles.

Curious about how he endured a decade in jail, I was taken aback by his response. He had taught illiterate Adivasi prisoners, many of whom were unaware of the reasons for their incarceration. Through distance education, he helped them graduate. Sai, 90% disabled and paralyzed from the waist down since childhood, credited his survival to the care of the Adivasi inmates. He also reflected on his mother's sacrifices—an illiterate daily-wage laborer who carried him to school each day, instilling in him the importance of education.

In an age where collective struggles often seem daunting, Sai embodied unwavering commitment and resilience. He expressed deep concern for the Adivasi communities and their challenges, highlighting the significance of collective action in finding strength and meaning.

During our conversation, he shared his health struggles but was more focused on reviving his activist work. Although he worried that his health might limit his activism, he was determined to complete unfinished writings and proposed creating a literary forum, seeking my involvement. I felt unqualified but admired his vision.

Sai was particularly anxious about his family's well-being, especially his daughter's education. We discussed avenues to reinstate his job, especially with a court hearing approaching regarding his termination despite his acquittal. Follow-

ing his advice, I sought assistance from Congress leader Digvijaya Singh, who was willing to help.

A few weeks later, I learned that Sai had been hospitalized for gallbladder stones. After a brief operation, he appeared revitalized. Yet, shortly after, complications arose. His pancreas became infected, leading to severe pain and further health decline. Despite our efforts to secure government assistance for his medical bills, we were unprepared for his passing on October 12 at 8:36 PM.

Sai's death, while not entirely unexpected, is profoundly unacceptable. Following the death of Father Stan Swamy, we are reminded of the consequences of state persecution. How could a frail, disabled man pose such a threat to the state? Perhaps his very fragility was seen as a challenge. In a nation striving for strength, we must question the frailty of a state that targets the most vulnerable among us.

This challenges previous assumptions about the duration of heightened vulnerability following viral infections.

Recent research has underscored a sig- critical. Researchers believe that Covid-19 may cause lasting damage to the cardiovascular system through various pathways, including inflammation and endothelial dysfunction. The virus can trigger a hyper-inflammatory response, leading to changes in blood vessel function and an increased likelihood of clot formation, both of which can contribute to heart attacks and strokes.

> Moreover, this prolonged risk highlights the importance of monitoring cardiovascular health in individuals who have recovered from Covid-19, particularly those with underlying health issues. The study advocates for healthcare providers to be vigilant in assessing heart health in patients with a history of Covid-19 infection, emphasizing preventive measures and interventions that could mitigate these risks.

> While further research is essential to establish causality and better understand the long-term implications, this study marks a crucial step in recognizing the broader consequences of Covid-19. It also reinforces the need for comprehensive healthcare strategies that address the multifaceted impacts of the virus beyond its acute phase. As we navigate the longterm effects of the pandemic, the findings serve as a reminder of the virus's enduring legacy on cardiovascular health.

Arundhati Roy's **Acceptance Speech for the PEN Pinter Prize 2024**

Writer and activist Arundhati Roy was honored with the PEN Pinter Prize 2024, a prestigious award recognizing those who embody the spirit of playwright Harold Pinter. In her acceptance speech on October 10, 2024, at the British Library, Roy expressed gratitude to English PEN and shared the award with Alaa Abd El-Fattah, a British-Egyptian writer and activist imprisoned in Egypt.

Roy began by acknowledging Abd El-Fattah's courage, noting that the Egyptian government deemed him too powerful a thinker to be released. She quoted him, emphasizing his persistent voice despite imprisonment: "[M]y words lost any power and yet they continued to pour out of me." Roy emphasized that they were listening closely to his words.

She extended greetings to her friend Naomi Klein and reflected on her comrades in prison in India, including activists and journalists such as Umar Khalid and Rona Wilson. Roy highlighted the lives devastated by incarceration, particularly in Kashmir, stating, "I speak to you, my friend Khurram Parvaiz, one of the most remarkable people I know, you've been in prison for three years."

Roy quoted Ruth Borthwick, Chair of English PEN, who had described the Pinter Prize as honoring those who seek to define "the real truth



of our lives." She pondered the word "unflinching," contrasting it with her own tendency to "flinch."

Drawing from a historical anecdote involving Father John Metcalf's plea against U.S. support for Nicaraguan Contras, Roy critiqued the unflinching attitudes of power structures that ignore the suffering of innocent people. She recounted Seitz's cold response to Metcalf's harrowing account of violence and destruction, noting the chilling absence of empathy.

Roy critiqued the U.S. narrative of

justifying military actions, referencing President Reagan's description of the Contras as "the moral equivalent of our Founding Fathers." She linked this rhetoric to other historical conflicts, including Vietnam, and questioned the moral implications of policies that lead to genocide and suffering.

In her powerful speech, Roy underscored the importance of bearing witness to the struggles of those silenced by oppression, and reaffirmed her commitment to truth-telling in a world that often prefers silence.



BJP's Political Flip-Flops: A Struggle for Credibility

During the recent Lok Sabha elections, the TMC's Partha Bhowmick instead. Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) fielded 110 candidates but only secured 41 victories, raising questions about its strategy. A notable case is Ashok Tanwar, a Dalit politician who was given a ticket for the Sirsa (SC) Lok Sabha constituency in Haryana, replacing sitting MP Sunita Duggal. Despite this move, Tanwar lost to Congress's Selja Kumari, a prominent Dalit leader.

Tanwar's political journey has been tumultuous. After previously serving as the state Congress president, he left the party to support the Jananayak Janata Party in the 2019 state elections. He later attempted to establish his own party, Apna Bharat Morcha, which failed to gain traction. Following a brief stint with the Trinamool Congress, Tanwar switched to the BJP, only to rejoin Congress just hours after rallying for a BJP candidate during the Haryana Assembly campaign.

This cycle of party-switching raises alarms within the BJP about its candidate selection process. In West Bengal, the BJP nominated sitting MP Arjun Singh, who had left the party for the Trinamool Congress after being elected in 2019. Despite his previous disloyalty, the BJP nominated him again, only for voters to choose

Union Home Minister Amit Shah recently stated that the BJP has a "very good digestion" when it comes to assimilating leaders from rival parties. While this strategy may seem pragmatic, it risks alienating the party's core base, especially when former rivals accused of corruption are welcomed back. This practice has tarnished the party's image and contributed to its reduced seat count in the Lok Sabha elec-

The BJP's alliances in Maharashtra exemplify this struggle. The party's decision to partner with the Ajit Pawar-led faction of the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) contradicted its earlier stance against corruption. Similarly, the induction of former chief minister Ashok Chavan, previously accused of corruption, further diluted the party's credibility among voters.

These political flip-flops have not only disappointed party cadres but have also undermined the BJP's ideological integrity. In West Bengal, the BJP's recruitment drive ahead of the 2021 assembly polls, aimed at attracting TMC leaders, backfired, leaving the party in a precarious position post-election.







Teams formed to enforce dust control measures In Delhi: CM Atishi

On October 15, Chief Minister Atishi announced the deployment of 99 inspection teams across Delhi to monitor compliance with dust mitigation measures at construction sites, following the implementation of Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) Stage 1. This decision comes in light of recent declines in air quality, with the city experiencing a rise in "good air days" earlier this year.

The announcement followed a high-level meeting led by Atishi, attended by representatives from various departments, including the Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC), Public Works Department (PWD), and Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC). Atishi highlighted the importance of addressing pollution, noting the urgency to implement the first stage of GRAP as air quality dipped into the "poor" category.

Under GRAP Stage 1, 33 teams from the DPCC, revenue, and industry departments will conduct inspections at both private and government construction sites, ensuring adherence to dust control measures. These teams are required to submit daily reports to the 'Green War Room,' which oversees air quality management in the city.

Additionally, the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) has dispatched 79 teams for daytime monitoring and 75 teams for nighttime operations to ensure proper disposal of construction waste. To combat biomass burning, 116 teams will work continuously.

Road dust control is a critical focus, with the PWD responsible for repairing potholes to minimize dust accumulation. To further address air quality, anti-smog guns will be deployed extensively, with 200 from the PWD, 80 from the DMRC, 30 from the MCD, and 14 from the NCRTC.

Atishi also directed traffic police to pinpoint congestion hotspots, ensuring adequate personnel are deployed to manage traffic and reduce vehicle emissions, thereby contributing to improved air quality in the capital.

Arrests in Baba Siddique Murder Case: Mumbai Police Detain Fourth Suspect

The Mumbai police have arrested a fourth suspect connection the murder of NCP leader and former Maharashtra minister Baba Siddique. The latest arrest involves 23-yearold Harishkumar Balakram, who is originally from Bahraich in Uttar



Pradesh. According to officials, Balakram, who was working as a scrap dealer in Pune, played a role in the conspiracy to kill Siddique and was apprehended in Bahraich.

Prior to Balakram's arrest, three individuals had already been detained. These included alleged shooters Gurmail Baljit Singh, also 23 and a resident of Haryana, and 19-year-old Dharmaraj Rajesh Kashyap from Uttar Pradesh. The police also arrested Pravin Lonkar, identified as a co-conspirator from Pune. Another suspected shooter, Shivkumar Gautam, remains at large.

Baba Siddique, aged 66, was attacked on Saturday night in Mumbai's Nirmal Nagar area, just outside his son Zeeshan Siddique's office. Eyewitnesses reported that three assailants waylaid him and opened fire. Siddique was quickly rushed to Lilavati Hospital but was declared dead upon arrival.

The police are continuing their investigation to gather more evidence and locate the remaining suspects involved in this high-profile case. The murder has sent shockwaves through the political landscape in Maharashtra, prompting increased security measures for public figures.



PM Modi Launches IMC 24: Advocates for Global Digital and Ethical Al Use

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the India Mobile Congress (IMC) 2024 on Tuesday, coinciding with the World Telecommunication Standardisation Assembly (WTSA) 2024. The event showcases advancements in mobile network connectivity, broadband adoption, and optical fibre expansion, with participation from major telecom operators like Reliance Jio and Airtel, as well as tech firms such as Xiaomi and Qualcomm.

During his address, PM Modi emphasized that India boasts 1.2 billion mobile users and over 950 million internet users, accounting for more than 40% of global real-time digital transactions. He noted that India leads in data affordabili-

ty, with the cost at just ₹12 per GB, significantly lower than many countries that charge 10-12 times more. The Prime Minister also highlighted the expansion of 5G network coverage to all districts and the substantial growth of the optical fibre network, which has increased to cover over eight times the distance between the Moon and Earth over the past decade.

Furthermore, Modi pointed out the rise in smartphone manufacturing within India and investments in semiconductor technology, aiming for completely "Made-in-India" handsets, including their components.

Airtel Chairman Sunil Mittal introduced

new anti-spam technology aimed at blocking fraudulent calls and messages, emphasizing the importance of user safety on telecom networks. Meanwhile, Kumar Mangalam Birla, promoter of Vodafone Idea, announced the kickstart of the telecom operator's capital expenditure cycle through a follow-on public offer (FPO) that garnered bids worth ₹90,000 crore, facilitating new deals with Ericsson, Nokia, and Samsung.

Birla expressed a commitment to empowering small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) with technologies like 5G, IoT, AI, and cloud services through their Vi Business ReadyForNext program, aiming to drive India's digital growth.



India Signs Mega Deal For 31 Predator Drones From US

In a significant boost to its armed forces, India has finalized a deal with the United States to acquire 31 MQ-9B Predator drones, enhancing its military capabilities. Under this agreement, the Indian Navy will receive 15 drones of the 'SeaGuardian' variant, while the Army and Air Force will each be allocated eight 'SkyGuardian' drones. The total cost of the deal is expected to be under \$3.5 billion.

The acquisition was approved by the Cabinet Committee on Security earlier this month and will proceed under a Foreign Military Sales contract with American manufacturer General Atomics Aeronautical Systems (GA-ASI). The MQ-9B Predator drone is a high-altitude, long-endurance unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) capable of flying for 40 hours at altitudes exceeding 40,000 feet, with an external payload capacity of 2,155 kg.

Beyond its surveillance capabilities, the MQ-9B is armed with strike missiles, enabling it to engage targets with precision. Its advanced features include automated take-offs and landings, and it can seamlessly integrate into civil airspace.

The versatility of the MQ-9B makes it ideal for various missions, including land and maritime surveillance, anti-submarine and anti-surface warfare, electronic warfare, and expeditionary operations aimed at addressing specific crises.

This deal underscores the growing U.S.-India defense partnership, which has seen significant progress over the past decade. Matthew Miller, a spokesperson for the U.S. State Department, emphasized the strategic importance of the deal during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit last year, noting its potential to enhance technology cooperation and military collaboration in the Indo-Pacific region.



Nitin Gadkari Advocates for Ethanol and Flex Fuels in India

Union Minister Nitin Gadkari emphasized the importance of promoting ethanol and flex fuels during a review meeting with the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM) on Tuesday. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu stated on Tuesday that Israel will independently determine its response to Iran's recent missile attack, which involved around 200 missiles fired at Israel earlier this month. This declaration comes as tensions rise between Israel and Iran, particularly following the death of Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah and Iranian general Abbas Nilforoushan in an Israeli strike in Bei-

Netanyahu's comments contrast with warnings from U.S. President Joe Biden, who has advised against targeting Iranian nuclear or oil facilities to avoid escalating the conflict. While U.S. officials reported that Netanyahu assured Washington he would only target military sites, Netanyahu's office emphasized that Israel would prioritize its national interests in decision-making.

As the situation intensifies, Israel has also engaged in retaliatory strikes against Hezbollah positions in Lebanon. Israeli military operations have reportedly hit multiple locations, including hospitals in the Bekaa Valley, raising concerns about civilian casualties. Since the escalation of violence last month, over 1,315 people have died in Lebanon, with many more displaced due to the ongoing conflict.

Hezbollah has responded with its own attacks, including targeting Israeli troops and claiming to have downed an Israeli drone. The group has framed its actions as support for Palestinian militants in Gaza, further complicating the regional dynamics.

Humanitarian conditions in Gaza continue to deteriorate, with over 42,000 reported deaths, primarily among civilians, due to Israel's retaliatory strikes following a deadly Hamas attack on October 7. International organizations have called for urgent assistance as families in the region face dire circumstances amid the ongoing violence. The UN has raised alarms about the situation, emphasizing the need for humanitarian support.

India-Canada Diplomatic Crisis Escalates Over Nijjar **Killing Allegations**

India and Canada are embroiled in a severe diplomatic crisis following Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's accusation that Indian agents were involved in the killing of Khalistani terrorist Hardeep Singh Nijjar in Canada. India has categorically denied these allegations, labeling them "absurd" and "politically motivated."

On October 15, Canada expelled six Indian diplomats, including the Acting High Commissioner, in connection with the investigation into Nijjar's murder, which occurred in British Columbia in June 2023. In retaliation, India announced the expulsion of six Canadian diplomats, escalating tensions between the two nations.

Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) Commissioner Mike Duheme claimed law enforcement had credible intelligence suggesting Indian government involvement in criminal activities, including threats to the South Asian community in Canada. He emphasized the importance of cooperation in addressing these threats.

India's Ministry of External Affairs strongly rejected Canada's claims, asserting that the allegations are part of a political agenda by Trudeau's government, which has historically provided a platform for anti-India extremists. The Ministry condemned Canada's lack of evidence supporting its assertions.

The strained relations between India and Canada date back several years, marked by incidents involving Khalistani extremists. Key events include the 2018 invitation of a convicted terrorist to a Canadian event and the vandalism of Hindu temples in Canada. Trudeau's earlier comments about anti-India activities during the G20 summit further strained ties.



As tensions rise, Trudeau accused India of engaging in "coercive behavior" against Canadians and insisted that Canadian law enforcement had attempted to cooperate with India on these issues but faced repeated refusals.

Chinese premier inaugurates Pakistani airport in militancyprone province

China's Premier Li Qiang recently visited Pakistan to inaugurate the New Gwadar International Airport (NGIA), a significant project funded by Beijing in a region frequently targeted by separatist groups. During a ceremony held on October 14, 2024, in Islamabad, Premier Li and Pakistan's Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif unveiled a plaque to mark the airport's completion.

Although Li did not visit Balochistan directly, he "virtually" inaugurated the airport from the capital, located approximately 2,000 kilometers (1,240 miles) away. The NGIA is situated near Gwadar Port, a cornerstone of the multi-billion-dollar China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), which connects China's Xinjiang region to Pakistan's coastline.

At the ceremony, Premier Li emphasized China's commitment to collaboration with Pakistan, stating, "China will continue to work with Pakistan to uphold the principle of planning together, building together, and benefiting together." This partnership is seen as crucial, given Beijing's longstanding support for Islamabad, particularly in providing financial assistance during economic challenges.

Despite the celebratory occasion, an aviation official confirmed to AFP that the airport is not yet operational for flights, although it is ready for operations. The completion of the airport is a vital step for the region, aiming to enhance connectivity and bolster economic growth.

Li's visit to Pakistan comes ahead of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit, which Islamabad is hosting. Video footage released by the South showed North Korean soldiers carrying out the explosions, producing thick smoke clouds as they blew up sections of both the Gyeongui and Donghae roads.



South Korea's unification ministry condemned the actions, labeling them as provocations and emphasizing the costs incurred in building the infrastructure. Meanwhile, China has urged all parties to de-escalate tensions on the peninsula.

In a related development, Kim Yo Jong, sister of the North Korean leader, accused the South of deploying drones into their airspace, asserting that the provocateurs would face serious consequences. Activist groups in South Korea have historically used balloons and small drones to send propaganda into the North.

Reliance Industries Reports 3.62% Decline in Q2 Net Profit

India's Oil Meal Exports Plummet 35% in September Amid Market Challenges

India's oil meal exports, crucial for animal feed, fell 35% in September, totaling 213,744 tonnes compared to 330,567 tonnes in September 2023, as reported by the Solvent Extractors Association of India (SEA). From April to September of FY24, overall exports decreased by 9%, reaching 2,082,533 tonnes, down from 2,276,120 tonnes in the same period last year. This decline is primarily attributed to reduced exports of rapeseed meal and castor seed meal.

The drop in oil meal exports is concerning for the agricultural sector, particularly given the global demand for animal feed ingredients. Key factors contributing to this decline include unfavorable market conditions, increased competition from other countries, and poten-



tial trade barriers. As a result, Indian exporters face challenges in maintaining their market share in the international arena.

The SEA emphasizes the importance of improving the quality and competitiveness of Indian oil meals to regain lost ground. This may involve enhancing processing technologies, adopting better agricultural practices, and exploring new markets to diversify export opportunities. SBI cuts loan interest rate by 25 bps on this short-term tenure

The State Bank of India (SBI) has announced an update to its marginal cost of funds-based lending rate (MCLR), reducing the interest rate for one tenure by 25 basis points (bps). This revision comes into effect on October 15, with other rates remaining unchanged.



In terms of other lending rates, SBI's base rate remains at 10.40%, with the BPLR updated to 15.15% per annum. The bank's home loan External Benchmark Lending Rate (EBLR) is currently 9.15%.

SBI's current base rate stands at 10.40%, while the Benchmark Prime Lending Rate (BPLR) is at 15.15%, as of September 15. The interest rates for home loans at SBI range from 8.50% to 9.65%, depending on the borrower's CIBIL score.

The updated MCLR rates are now set between 8.20% and 9.1%. The overnight MCLR is now at 8.20%, while the one-month MCLR has been lowered from 8.45% to 8.20%. The six-month MCLR is fixed at 8.85%, and the one-year MCLR has been revised to 8.95%. Additionally, the two-year MCLR is set at 9.05%, and the threeyear MCLR is at 9.1%.

Interest rates on SBI home loans are influenced by the borrower's CIBIL score, which means those with higher credit scores may secure lower rates. The SBI home loan website also notes that any changes in the benchmark rate, such as the Repo Rate, will directly affect the interest rates on home and related loans. An increase in the Repo Rate would lead to a corresponding rise in home loan interest rates.

This adjustment in MCLR is expected to impact borrowers looking to take out loans from SBI, offering a slightly lower interest option for those who qualify under the new MCLR framework.

SEBI increases position limits for trading members in index F&O contracts

On October 15, 2024, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) announced an upward revision in the position limits for trading members in index futures and options (F&O) contracts. This change aims to enhance liquidity and trading capacity in the capital markets.

According to the new guidelines, the cumulative position limits for trading members-encompassing both client and proprietary trades—are now set at ₹7,500 crore or 15% of the total open interest (OI) in the market, whichever is greater. Previously, this limit was only ₹500 crore or 15% of the total OI.

The revised Master Circular on Stock Exchanges and Clearing Corporations specifies that this limit applies separately to all open positions in futures and options contracts related to a specific underlying index. SEBI highlighted that position limits will be monitored for index futures and index options individually.



In light of the dynamic nature of open interest, SEBI has introduced measures for better clarity among market participants. Similar to the currency derivatives segment, the positions in the equity derivatives market will now be monitored based on the total open interest at the close of the previous

trading day. Furthermore, if there is a decrease in market open interest compared to the previous day's figures, market participants may inadvertently exceed the specified limits without altering their positions throughout the day. In such cases of "passive breaches," SEBI has clarified that market participants will not face penalties nor will they be required to unwind their positions.

These adjustments are expected to foster a more conducive trading environment, allowing market participants greater flexibility in managing their positions while maintaining regulatory oversight. The move is seen as a significant step towards enhancing the overall efficiency and stability of India's capital markets.





WhatsApp Bans Over 8 Million **Accounts to Combat Abuse**



Meta-owned WhatsApp has announced the banning of over 8.4 million accounts in India during August 2024 as part of its efforts to combat abuse and uphold user privacy. This move is detailed in WhatsApp's latest transparency report, which aligns with India's

Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021.

The report reveals that 8,458,000 accounts were banned, a significant increase in enforcement actions compared to previous

months. Of these, 1,661,000 accounts were identified and banned before any user complaints were lodged, thanks to WhatsApp's proactive detection systems. These automated tools monitor suspicious activities, such as bulk messaging, which is often linked to scams or misuse of the platform.

Additionally, WhatsApp received 10,707 user complaints via its grievance mechanisms, which were addressed to its India Grievance Officer through email and postal methods. Complaints included ban appeals, account support, safety concerns, and other user-related issues, with WhatsApp taking action on 93 of these cases.


Accounts are typically banned for violating WhatsApp's terms of service, including sending spam or engaging in bulk messaging. Those involved in illegal activities

under Indian law are also swiftly flagged and banned. WhatsApp responds to user complaints regarding abusive, harassing, or inappropriate behaviour, further strengthening its commitment to a safer platform.

The abuse detection process employed by WhatsApp occurs in three stages: during user registration, throughout ongoing user activities, and in response to user feedback. By analyzing user interactions, WhatsApp can identify and take action against suspicious or harmful behaviours. Depending on the severity of the violation, accounts may face temporary suspensions or permanent bans.

This proactive approach reflects WhatsApp's ongoing commitment to maintaining a secure environment for its users while adhering to regulatory standards in India.

Woman Gets 'Miss You, Says I-Pill' Notification From Zepto



Bengaluru-based quick commerce platform Zepto has landed in hot water after sending an unsolicited notification that has drawn widespread criticism. Customer Pallavi Pareek received a message that read, "I miss you, Pallavi. Says i-Pill emergency contraceptive pill," complete with three teary-eyed emoticons.

Ms. Pareek quickly shared her concerns on LinkedIn, emphasizing the inappropriateness of the message. She stated, "First of all, I have never ordered an emergency pill from you. Even if I had, this is not something that should be described as missing me or that I should be missing it." She questioned Zepto's intent, asking, "Are you suggesting that I need to take an emergency contraceptive?" and expressing her confusion about receiving such a notification when she had not placed any order.

As a professional focused on workplace sexual harassment prevention and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI), Ms. Pareek highlighted the messaging's insensitivity. She stated, "Messaging is appropriate only if it is sensitive, humorous, or logical. I draw the line when notifications become flirty or sleazy. This is just too much."

Despite her criticisms, Ms. Pareek made it clear that she enjoys using the app and relies heavily on quick commerce services in her daily life. "This post is meant to highlight the flaw in thoughtless logic and messaging, not to criticize the i-Pill promotion or its availability," she clarified.




