HANDOVER ALL SHOPS TO ME, I WILL GIVE YOU A SHARE

BASHYAM PRAVEEN'S LIQUOR DEAL



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Mr. Bhashyam Praveen, MLA of Pedakurapadu in Guntur District, has taken a controversial approach to the liquor business. While shop-sharing is common across districts and constituencies, MLA Bhashyam Praveen has introduced a new tactic in his constituency. He reportedly summoned all those who won liquor shop licenses in the lottery and asked them to hand over the shops to him. He assured them that his office would handle the accounts, and 50% of the profits would be shared with the original license holders. This news has been circulating widely throughout the constituency.

The liquor traders were shocked by the MLA's demand and are now seeking an appointment with Chief Minister Mr. N. Chandrababu Naidu. They are expected to meet with the Chief Minister in the next two days. Bhashyam Praveen, who is a first-time MLA, won the seat riding the alliance wave. His brother, Bhashyam Jagadish, reportedly manages all of the MLA's affairs on the ground, despite having a rowdy sheet filed against him. It was Jagadish who allegedly led the discussions with the liquor shop owners on behalf of the MLA.



timately, Praveen's syndicate secured only four shops in the constituency, failing in their attempt to dominate the market. After this setback, Praveen began calling those who had secured shops, allegedly threatening them to hand over control. In one instance, a person from Vijayawada who won licenses for eight shops in Dharanikota was reportedly subjected to intense pressure.

Under the proposed deal, the Bhashyam family would take over the liquor shops without paying any fee or deposit, manage the business, and split 50% of the profits with the original license holders. These shop owners would effectively become spectators, forced to accept whatever share is released by the MLA.

Chief Minister Naidu has already issued serious warnings to MLAs regarding involvement in the liquor business. He made it clear that neither TDP nor Janasena MLAs should participate in liquor-related ventures. Despite this, MLA Bhashyam Praveen allegedly held meetings both before and after Naidu's directive. Now, everyone is waiting for the Chief Minister's response to the liquor shop owners of Pedakurapadu and how he will address MLA Bhashyam Praveen's actions.

According to sources, MLA Praveen threatened many potential bidders, allegedly discouraging them from submitting tenders for the liquor shops. His plan was to monopolize the shops by forming a syndicate with his associates. However, Chief Minister Naidu's insistence on online bidding led hundreds of people to file tenders online, despite Praveen's efforts. Before the online bidding, only 40 applications had been submitted. Ul-

DCM Pawan Kalyan to Visit Gurla Village Amid Diarrhea Outbreak



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: AP Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan is set to visit Gurla village in Vizianagaram district today, October 21, in response to a severe diarrhea outbreak affecting the area. The visit comes as the village grapples with a health crisis, where a significant number of residents are suffering from vomiting and diarrhea, leading to the unfortunate deaths of four individuals in just one day.

Free Gas Cylinders to Be Provided from Diwali - Minister Nadendla

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a significant announcement, Andhra Pradesh Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar stated that the state government is set to provide free gas cylinders to eligible households starting from Diwali. This initiative is part of the “Super Six” promises made during the recent elections, where the TDP alliance pledged to offer three free gas cylinders per year to women.

Minister Nadendla emphasized that the implementation of this scheme is a priority for the coalition government. “We will provide three gas cylinders free of charge per year to eligible households,” he confirmed. The initiative is expected to incur an annual cost of approximately ₹3,000 crores.

Kollu Ravindra Challenges YS Jagan to Collect Sand Himself Using a Tractor

Kollu Ravindra Advocates for Rs 264 Crore Income from Sand Management

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Minister of Excise and Mines Kollu Ravindra has emphasized the need for Rs 264 crore in revenue from sand management to effectively implement the free sand policy and enhance convenience for the common man. Speaking at the TDP central office in Mangalagiri, he stated that only operational charges would be collected, allowing residents to transport sand at no cost using tractors, a new option that expands on the previous policy which permitted free transport only via dump trucks.

Ravindra invited former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy to come and collect sand himself using a tractor, highlighting the ease of the new system. He criticized the previous administration for allegedly enabling rampant corruption in the sand and liquor sectors, accusing YCP leaders of pilfering Rs 1,000 crore in sand revenues. He also noted that the National Green Tribunal had imposed a fine of Rs 100 crore on illegal sand mining activities during Jagan's tenure.

Regarding liquor regulation, Ravindra pointed out that under the YCP government, there were 856 cases registered for the sale of adulterated liquor and an additional 930 cases for selling liquor above the maximum retail price (MRP) in government-run shops. He revealed that about 40 lakh individuals reportedly fell ill due



to adulterated alcohol during that period.

To address these issues, Ravindra announced plans to establish a committee, led by a retired judge, to determine liquor pricing. He also indicated that applications would soon be invited for 340 shops designated for stone cutters, as part of the government's broader strategy to improve oversight and management in both the sand and liquor sectors.

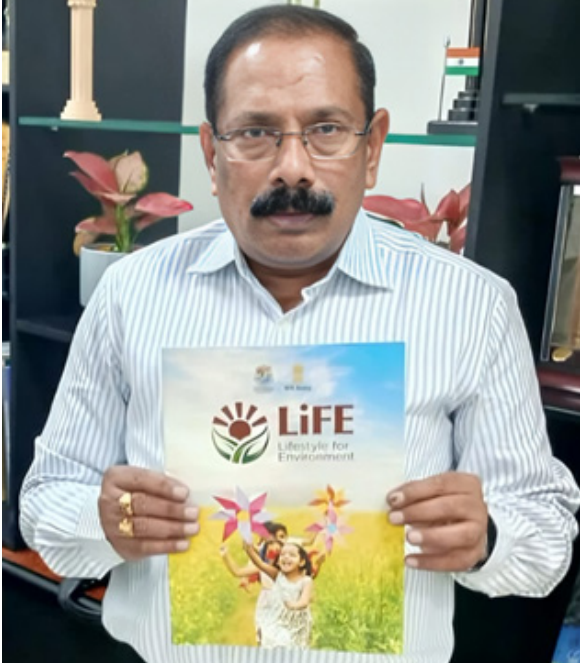
Special Book on Mission LIFE Released in Amaravati by K. Vijayanand

The event concluded with a call to action for all citizens to engage in sustainable practices, reinforcing the message that protecting the planet is a shared responsibility.

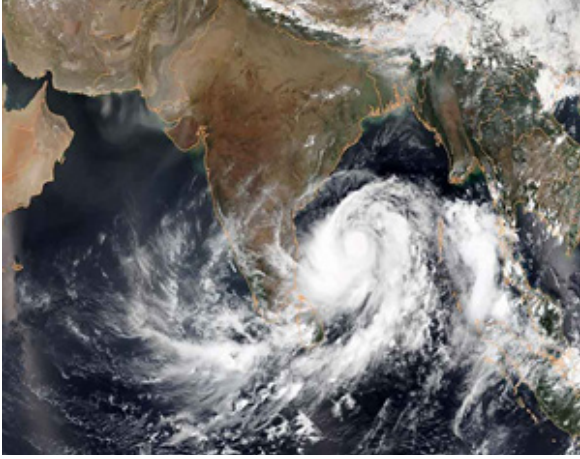
Cyclone 'Dana' Develops in Bay of Bengal, Heavy Rains Expected in AP

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Regional Meteorological Organization (RMC) in Chennai has announced that a low-pressure area forming in the Bay of Bengal is expected to strengthen and develop into a cyclone named 'Dana' in the coming days.

The RMC indicated that this low pressure will form over the east-central Bay of Bengal, adjacent to the North Andaman Sea, within the next 24 hours. The system is projected to move northwestward and enter the southwestern Bay of Bengal.

According to the India Meteorological Department (IMD), this depression is likely to transform into a full-fledged cyclone by October 22 and could further intensify by October 23.

As a result of these developments, heavy rainfall is anticipated across various regions in Andhra Pradesh. Coastal Andhra and Yanam can expect heavy rains on the 20th and 24th of this month, while scattered rainfall is also likely in the Rayalaseema region on the 20th.



Authorities have advised fishermen to return to shore by October 21, as conditions in the sea are expected to deteriorate with the approaching cyclone. Local residents are urged to stay alert and take necessary precautions in anticipation of the severe weather.

Officials continue to monitor the situation and will provide updates as more information becomes available.

Nara Lokesh's Fierce Allegations Against Jagan

Lokesh accused Jagan of profiting from the spread of drugs and ganja across Andhra Pradesh, labeling his governance as one that enabled criminals. He further claimed that Jagan shielded criminals, including his own party members involved in serious offenses like murder and gang rape. Highlighting the increasing crime rates, Lokesh pointed to over 2,000 murders of women and the disappearance of 30,000 women during Jagan's rule, alleging that the former CM did nothing to address these issues.

Lokesh also criticized the lack of effective implementation of the Disha Act, aimed at punishing rapists, accusing Jagan of creating a false narrative around its success. He slammed the ganja mafia that thrived under Jagan's rule, claiming that it had deep roots across the state and contributed to rising crime rates.

Furthermore, Lokesh praised Chandrababu Naidu's leadership in combating factionalism, religious strife, and crimi-

nal activities, while contrasting it with Jagan's alleged failure to maintain law and order. Lokesh pledged that under the current TDP government, they would eradicate the "poisonous seeds" planted by Jagan's administration and work towards a crime-free Andhra Pradesh.

The comments have stirred political controversy, raising questions about law enforcement and governance in the state under the previous and current administrations.

YCP Eyes Replacement for Grandhi Srinivas as Bhimavaram Politics Heat Up

TPN, Sekhar: Grandhi Srinivas, the former YCP MLA of Bhimavaram who won the 2019 elections by defeating Pawan Kalyan. Now facing uncertainty about his political future. Despite being seen as a "trendsetter" and having high hopes of securing a cabinet position, Srinivas was never given a ministerial role, leading to growing dissatisfaction within the party. After losing in the 2024 elections, his hopes for political advancement seem to have diminished.



Reports suggest that Narasimharaju recently met with Jagan Mohan Reddy to discuss local politics, signaling that the YCP leadership may be preparing to officially announce him as the new in-charge for Bhimavaram.

However, this move could create tensions between Grandhi Srinivas and Narasimharaju, especially given their close relationship. Political analysts are also questioning how the Kapu vote bank, which leans heavily towards Janasena in Bhimavaram, will react to this potential shift in leadership. There is also speculation that the YCP is considering dividing the Bhimavaram constituency, potentially boosting their chances in future elections.

With these developments, the political dynamics in Bhimavaram are expected to shift, as the YCP weighs its options for leadership in the constituency.

TDP has selected Alapati Rajendra Prasad as the candidate for the Krishna-Guntur Graduate MLC seat, while Perabattula Rajasekhara will represent the party for the East and West Godavari districts. TDP state president Palla Srinivasa Rao released an official statement confirming these selections.



Meanwhile, the YSR Congress Party (YCP) has named Ponnuru Gautam Reddy as its candidate for the

Krishna-Guntur Graduate MLC seat, setting the stage for a competitive election.

Jagan Criticizes Chandrababu's Govt for Public Health Collapse Amid Vizianagaram Tragedy



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: YSR Congress Party (YCP) leader and former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy has fiercely criticized the public health crisis under the governance of N. Chandrababu Naidu, pointing to the recent diarrhea outbreak in Vizianagaram district as a glaring example of systemic failure. In an emotional post on X (formerly Twitter), Jagan expressed his frustration, highlighting the deaths of 11 people and the hospitalization of over 100 others due to the outbreak in Gurla Mandal.

Jagan stated that this incident illustrates the collapse of the state's public health system, accusing the government of failing to provide quality healthcare to the victims. Despite the

proximity of well-equipped hospitals in Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam, he lamented that patients were forced to receive treatment in makeshift conditions, such as on benches in local schools. This, he claimed, reflected the government's negligence in managing emergency medical responses.

In his criticism, Jagan accused the government of being distracted by scandals related to liquor and sand, while essential services such as the 104 and 108 ambulance systems had deteriorated. He also took aim at the government's handling of the Arogya Sri health scheme, noting that Rs. 1,800 crore in dues had been pending since March, and specialist doctors had been removed from critical health centers, weakening village clinics and public hospitals.

Jagan condemned the "zero vacancy policy" touted by the Chandrababu government, pointing out that it has led to a severe shortage of medical professionals. He also alleged that the establishment of new medical colleges has been mismanaged, claiming they are being privatized. Jagan called for urgent government intervention, emphasizing the need for better medical care and clean drinking water in the affected villages.

Botsa Criticizes NDA Govt Over Diarrhea Outbreak in Gurla Village



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In Gurla village, Vizianagaram district, a severe outbreak of diarrhea has claimed multiple lives, sparking criticism from YCP MLC Botsa Satyanarayana. Alleging that 16 people have died due to the spread of the disease, Botsa accused the NDA government of negligence, stating that these were not natural deaths but a result of poor governance and failure to maintain basic hygiene standards.

During his visit to the village, Botsa demanded immediate compensation for the families of the deceased, highlighting the need for accountability. He emphasized that the situation in the village had deteriorated due to the government's failure to provide safe drinking water and maintain proper sanitation. The YCP leader pointed out that such a dire situation had never occurred in the past, criticizing the current administration for allowing the outbreak to escalate to this level.

Botsa's remarks have intensified calls for urgent government intervention, as residents of Gurla continue to grapple with the impact of the diarrhea outbreak.



Roja Slams NDA Govt Over Girl's Tragic Death in YSR District

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a shocking incident in YSR district, a young Intermediate student died after her ex-boyfriend poured petrol on her and set her on fire. The incident, which took place in Badvel, has drawn widespread condemnation, with former minister and YCP leader R.K. Roja strongly criticizing the state government for failing to protect girls.

Roja expressed deep anguish over the tragedy, condemning the coalition government for turning Andhra Pradesh into what she referred to as "Achyachandhra Pradesh" and "rape Andhra Pradesh," highlighting the alarming increase in crimes against women. In a video shared on social media, she pointed to the heart-wrenching scene of the deceased girl's mother, who was seen grieving the loss of her daughter. Roja questioned whether the government was hearing the cries of such mothers who have lost their children to violence.

She criticized Chandrababu Naidu, Home Minister Anita, and Pawan Kalyan, holding them responsible for the deteriorating law and order situation in the state.

Notices Issued to Duvvada Srinivas and Divvala Madhuri On Tirumala Photoshoot Controversy

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The romantic saga of Duvvada Srinivas and Divvala Madhuri, which started in Utarandhra, has now become a hot topic across Andhra Pradesh. The latest development in their story revolves around an alleged controversial photoshoot at the Tirumala temple during the Srivari Brahmotsavam festival. This incident has drawn the ire of devotees and temple authorities alike, leading to a police investigation.

The Tirumala One Town Police have issued 41A notices to both Duvvada Srinivas and Madhuri, speeding up the investigation into their actions at the sacred site. The Tirumala Tirupa-

ti Devasthanams (TTD) raised objections, accusing the couple of hurting religious sentiments by conducting a pre-wedding photoshoot and creating reels at the holy shrine. TTD vigilance officials filed a formal complaint, prompting the police to register a case on October 10th.

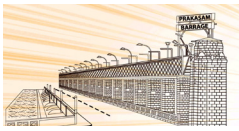
Allegations surfaced that on October 4th, during the Srivari Brahmotsavam, Madhuri and Srinivas engaged in a photoshoot in public areas of the temple, including Mada Streets and Pushkarini. This led to social media outrage, with critics accusing them of desecrating the sanctity of the temple. TTD filed complaints under three sections, and a team of police has

been dispatched to Tekkali, Srikakulam district, to serve notices directly to Madhuri.

While Duvvada and Madhuri claim they did not engage in any inappropriate behavior or reels, suspicions of a political conspiracy have emerged. Hindu organizations have also joined the protest, demanding strict action and calling for the couple to be permanently barred from visiting Tirumala.

The controversy has fueled heated debates, with Srinivas defending Madhuri and challenging those who filed cases. Meanwhile, the TTD investigation continues, with more drama likely to unfold in the coming days.





BJP MP Purandheswari Demands Severe Punishment for Kadapa Murder Culprit



TPN, Vijayawada: BJP Andhra Pradesh President Daggu-bati Purandheswari has strongly condemned the gruesome murder of a student in Kadapa district, where she was set on fire by her lover. Addressing the media on Sunday at the BJP office, Purandheswari called for stringent action against the culprit and anyone who may have aided him in this heinous crime.

The incident, which has sent shockwaves across the state, involved Vignesh, a resident of Badvel town, who allegedly killed the young student by pouring petrol on her and setting her on fire after she refused his advances. Despite being married for six months, Vignesh continued to pursue his ex-girlfriend and lured her into

meeting him under false pretenses. The victim, a first-year intermediate student, tragically succumbed to her injuries after being rushed to Kadapa RIMS with over 80% burns.

Purandheswari expressed her deep anguish over the incident and stressed that such acts of violence against women must be dealt with severely to deter future occurrences. "The accused must face the full extent of the law, and anyone complicit in this crime must also be held accountable," she stated.

The young man's obsession with his ex-girlfriend, despite being married and expecting a child with his wife, led to this horrific act. He allegedly pressured the girl to marry him, and when she resisted, he set her on fire. A lorry driver passing by attempted to save the girl by using a blanket to extinguish the flames, but it was too late to prevent her from sustaining fatal injuries.

Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has taken a serious stance on the matter, ordering Kadapa SP Harshavardhan Raju to take immediate action. Special police teams have been formed to apprehend Vignesh, who remains at large. The tragic incident has sparked widespread outrage, with calls for swift justice for the young victim.

Union Bank Manager Prabhavathi Hari Accused of Fraud in Nujiveedu



TPN, Nujiveedu: Union Bank manager Prabhavathi Hari has been accused of trapping a local man, Kavuluri Yogeeshwara Rao, and allegedly swindling him out of money and gold. Yogeeshwara Rao expressed his grief, claiming that Prabhavathi's actions have caused him significant financial loss.

Yogeeshwara Rao lodged a formal complaint with the Nujiveedu po-



lice, who revealed during their investigation that Prabhavathi has been involved in multiple cases of fraud. Disturbing details about her alleged misconduct have emerged, suggesting that she has deceived several others in the past.

During a media debate on the matter, it was stated that Yogeeshwara Rao had always treated Prabhavathi with respect, referring to her as his

elder sister. However, he has challenged her to confront him in a live debate to clear the accusations she made against him. Yogeeshwara Rao also revealed that another victim, Tara Chaudhary, has accused Prabhavathi of similarly trapping her and stealing her gold and money.

It is alleged that Prabhavathi has a history of fraudulent activities, with several cases registered against her during the previous government. Many victims in the Nujiveedu area have reportedly fallen into her trap, losing their valuable assets.

Yogeeshwara Rao shared his frustration, stating that Prabhavathi's false allegations have compelled him to speak out. He claims to have evidence of Prabhavathi's deceptive actions, including incidents in Goa and hotels where she allegedly carried out fraudulent activities. He has urged women's groups to investigate the matter thoroughly, not only to help the victims but also to prevent further suffering caused by her actions.

Tragedy at Madalavari Gudem, Two Engineering Students Drown in Pond

TPN, Gannavaram: A tragic incident occurred when seven final-year B.Tech students from Lingayas Engineering College in Madalavari Gudem went to a nearby pond for a fun bath. What started as a carefree outing ended in disaster as two students, Paladugu Durga Rao and Jay Venkatesh, lost their lives while attempting to take selfies by the water.

The bodies of the two students were recovered and shifted to Gannavaram Government Hospital. Their grieving parents rushed to the scene, devastated by the loss and questioning why their children had left the college premises unsupervised.

The parents expressed deep concern about the college's responsibility, as they demanded answers from the management. However, the college administration provided vague and unsatisfactory explanations, further fu-

eling the frustration and anger of the grieving families.

The parents criticized the management, accusing them of collecting exorbitant fees while neglecting the safety and well-being of students. "The management of Lingayas College must take full responsibility for this tragedy," the parents cried, their voices filled with anguish.

When media representatives arrived at the college to seek more information, they were met with hostility. College security personnel locked the gates, preventing anyone from entering the premises, further adding to the outrage surrounding the incident.

The tragedy has raised serious questions about the college's role in ensuring the safety of its students, and the grieving families are demanding accountability from the institution.



Development of Villages is the Mission of the Govt - Giddalur MLA

Registration of Teacher Voters Extended Until November 6

TPN, Srikakulam: District Revenue Officer (DRO) M. Apparao has announced that all eligible teachers should register for voting in the upcoming Upadhyaya MLC elections for the Urtarandhra Combined Districts. In a video conference, he emphasized the importance of this registration process.

Apparao noted that the notification for voter registration was issued on September 30, in accordance with the rules set by the Election Commission. The registration process began on the same day and will remain open until November 6. A draft list of registered voters will be published on November 23, with objections accepted until December 9. The final list of voters will be released on December 30.

He urged authorities to pay close attention to the registration process, stating that teachers and



lecturers working in government, aided, and private secondary educational institutions are eligible to register. However, part-time teachers are not eligible for voter registration. Only those who have worked for at least three years in any educational institution beyond the secondary level within the last six years are qualified to apply.

Importantly, Apparao clarified that previous votes are no longer valid, meaning even those who have voted in the past must re-register. He was joined in the conference by DEO Tirumala Chaitanya, Regional Intermediate Officer Ravitinaidu, and C-Section Superintendent Rajeswara Rao, who all supported the initiative.

Let's Unite to Stop Human Trafficking, DSP Somanna and MLC Madhusudan

Pregnant Woman Carried for Five Kilometers Due to Lack of Roads In Alluri Dist

TPN, Alluri: In a heart-wrenching incident from Alluri Sitaramaraju District, a full-term pregnant woman, Badnaini Ramulamma from Karri Gada village in Gumma Panchayat, had to be carried in a makeshift dolly for five kilometers due to the absence of road access. Her husband, Badnaini Sanyasi Rao, and his elder brother, Badnaini Bojjanna, carried her from their hilltop village to the Gumma Panchayat center. From there, they managed to take her to the S Kota Area Hospital in Vizianagaram district by auto.

This incident highlights the continued struggles of tribal communities in the district, where road facilities remain non-existent, making it extremely difficult for residents to access essential services, particularly healthcare. Despite changes in government over the years, the tribals' hardships have not eased. Without proper road facilities, even ambulances are unable to reach these remote areas, forcing villagers to carry patients over long distances in precarious situations.

The tribals have expressed their frustration, urging the government to prioritize the construction of roads in hill villages. Many areas still rely on dollies to transport the sick to hospitals, especially pregnant women, whose access to timely medical care is critical. The lack of basic infrastructure continues to endanger the lives of both mothers and newborns, and the tribals are once again appealing to the government to provide much-needed road and transport facilities.



CPM - All Ponds in the District Should Be Filled with Water

TPN, Raptadu: The CPM district secretary, Rambhupal, has called for immediate action to fill all ponds in the district to assist farmers facing agricultural challenges. During a bus jatha organized by the CPM at the Rapatu bus stand on Saturday, Rambhupal emphasized the urgent need to address issues related to cultivation, drinking water, and farmer welfare.

Memo to Rayalaseema University Professor

Issuance of Memo and Investigation into Allegations of Misconduct

TPN, Kurnool: It has come to the attention of the university administration that certain actions on your part have raised concerns and led to controversy. Specifically, you invited students from the university hostels to your home to celebrate your birthday without obtaining prior permission from the hostel wardens. This incident, along with past allegations of misbehavior when you were an assistant professor at an engineering college, has led to further complaints from students.

It has been reported that you engaged in a confrontation with a hostel warden over taking female students out of the women's dormitory without approval. Additionally, there are allegations that you organized an unauthorized excursion for students and are forming a group within the university to target certain professors.

In response to these serious concerns, the university has issued this memo as a formal notice of investigation. A committee of three professors has been established to thoroughly review the allegations. Once the committee completes its investigation, appropriate actions will be taken based on the findings of their report.

We expect your full cooperation during this process. Please note that any further actions that violate university policies or put students at risk will be taken seriously and may lead to further disciplinary measures.



The Consequences of Yahya Sinwar's Death



The recent death of Yahya Sinwar, the chief of Hamas, on October 17, marks a significant turning point in the protracted Israel-Hamas conflict, which reignited dramatically after the October 7 attacks. Sinwar, who rose to prominence after the assassination of Ismail Haniyeh earlier this year, was responsible for orchestrating brutal assaults that resulted in over 1,200 Israeli fatalities. In response, Israeli military actions have led to approximately 42,000 Palestinian deaths in Gaza.

Following Sinwar's assassination, U.S. President Joe Biden and European leaders have once again called for a ceasefire, suggesting that this could be a chance to seek a path toward peace. However, Israel remains steadfast against a ceasefire, arguing it would allow Hamas to regroup and rearm. Israeli UN Ambassador Danny Danon articulated that the IDF will not relent until all hostages are freed and Hamas is thoroughly dismantled.

There are two key aspects to consider regarding Sinwar's death. On one hand, the circumstances surrounding his assassination highlight significant damage to Hamas's extensive underground tunnel systems. This degradation may indicate a weakening of the organization, potentially prompting remaining members to contemplate surrender and the release of hostages still held in

Gaza.

Conversely, Israel's history of targeting high-profile leaders is well-documented, and such actions have, at times, led to a resurgence in Hamas's military capabilities. Sinwar's deputy has already claimed that his death will only strengthen Hamas's resolve to resist Israeli actions.

Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has not indicated any intention to pursue a ceasefire, emphasizing that the conflict is ongoing. His government faces considerable internal opposition, particularly concerning the unresolved hostage situation. The war has taken a heavy toll on Israeli soldiers and has severely impacted the economy, further complicating public sentiment.

Looking ahead, Netanyahu's government may benefit from continued U.S. support, especially given the approaching elections. With both major political parties unlikely to oppose Israel's military operations, the potential for a ceasefire seems remote. As tensions rise, particularly with increased military engagements in Lebanon, both Israel and Hamas appear locked in a cycle of violence with no clear resolution in sight. This ongoing conflict underscores the complexities and challenges of achieving lasting peace in the region.

Misconception of Power: Extra-Territorial Assassinations and International Law

As diplomatic tensions rise between India and Canada over allegations of India targeting Khalistani activists—claims that India firmly denies—some segments of Indian media suggest that the ability to conduct extra-territorial assassinations signifies international power. This perspective fundamentally misinterprets how power interacts with international law and its evolution.

The post-World War II international legal framework is built upon two key principles: non-aggression, which seeks to limit unilateral use of force, and the legal equality of sovereign states, regardless of their relative power. These principles have often been contentious for the United States, which has historically aimed to reshape international law to establish a "first among equals" status, particularly concerning the use of force.

Detlev Vagts coined the term "hegemonic international law" to describe a scenario in which, despite formal equality among sovereign states, the legal framework inherently serves the interests of a dominant power—the hegemon, in this case, the US. This dynamic is particularly relevant in the realm of customary international law, where state practices shape evolving norms. When the hegemon disregards customary international law, its influence often results in its interpretations becoming the new standard. As former US Attorney General William H. Barr noted, "the way to change international law is to break it."



The historical evolution of customary international law regarding extra-territorial assassinations illustrates this concept well. For decades, such actions were viewed as severe violations of the territorial sovereignty of the host nation. Notably, in 1985, when Israel targeted PLO offices in Tunisia, the UN Security Council condemned the action. Despite 14 member states voting in favor of the resolution, the US abstained. A similar pattern emerged in 1988 when Israel assassinated PLO leader Khalil Al Wazir in Tunisia, leading to widespread condemnation, again with the US abstaining from censure.

The US has often flouted these legal restrictions. In 1986, Secretary of State George Shultz asserted the US right to use military force against states "supporting" terrorism, a position that faced international backlash but nonetheless justified US military action in Libya. In 1993, the US bombed Iraqi targets after an assassination attempt on President George H.W. Bush, further claiming self-defense with minimal international support. As late as 1998, US strikes against Al Qaeda were condemned by the Non-Aligned Movement for violating territorial sovereignty.

These incidents underscore the complexities of international power dynamics and the evolving nature of customary international law, highlighting the disparity between the actions of powerful states and the legal frameworks that ostensibly govern them.



The Historic Conversion of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar: A Day of Hope and Liberation

On October 14, 1956, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, a prominent leader and advocate for the rights of the Dalit community, orchestrated one of the largest religious conversions in history, converting to Buddhism along with approximately 500,000 followers in Nagpur. This monumental event, marked by its peaceful nature, came after Ambedkar's life-long battle against caste discrimination.

Born into a Hindu 'untouchable' caste, Ambedkar faced systemic oppression but rose to become one of the most educated and revered figures of his time, earning degrees from prestigious institutions such as Columbia University and the London School of Economics. He returned to India and emerged as a key leader during significant movements advocating for the rights of Dalits, including the Mahad water tank movement and the Kalam temple entry movement. His resolve to fight against the entrenched caste system was unwavering.

Ambedkar chose Nagpur as the site for this transformative event, though Mumbai was also a contender. In his address, he emphasized the historical significance of Nagpur, linking it to the Nagas—ancestors who resisted Aryan dominance. His conversion was not merely a personal choice but a collective act of empowerment for the oppressed.

Rejecting the hierarchical caste system detailed in Hindu scriptures like the Manusm-

riti, Ambedkar criticized the societal norms that relegated Shudras to menial roles, advocating instead for education and equality for all. He saw Buddhism as a path to liberation, offering a framework for equality that resonated deeply with the downtrodden.

Despite political apprehensions regarding the timing of the conversion amid upcoming elections, the event in Nagpur drew significant attention. Ambedkar acknowledged the disappointment of his supporters in Mumbai but reassured them that further ceremonies would follow.

Tragically, Ambedkar passed away just weeks after the Nagpur conversion, on December 6, 1956. His death prompted an outpouring of grief, with an estimated one million people attending his funeral in Mumbai. During this somber occasion, many of his followers seized the moment to embrace Buddhism, fulfilling his wishes for a mass conversion.

The second wave of conversion in Mumbai saw approximately 1.3 million people convert to Buddhism on December 7, further solidifying Ambedkar's legacy. Each year, thousands commemorate this historic day by visiting Deekshabhoomi in Nagpur, reaffirming their commitment to the path laid out by Dr. Ambedkar and Gautam Buddha, a testament to their ongoing quest for dignity and equality.



India, Canada, and the Five Eyes: Navigating Geopolitical Tensions

The recent geopolitical tensions between India and Canada over allegations of extra-territorial killings have sparked varied perspectives in Indian media. Some commentators argue that India lacks the capability to discreetly eliminate threats, contrasting it with Israel's efficient operations through Mossad. Others refute these claims entirely, asserting that India does not engage in such practices.

Another narrative suggests that Western powers are leveraging these accusations to undermine India's rise as a significant global player, especially as a non-white, non-Anglospheric nation. Proponents of this theory often highlight the Five Eyes intelligence alliance—comprised of the United States, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand—as a key player in this alleged conspiracy.

The Five Eyes serves as an established intelligence-sharing network among its member countries. Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's accusations against India are said to rely on intelligence gathered through this alliance, raising suspicions about the motives behind such information, especially given its covert nature.

Intelligence, a vital tool of statecraft, allows countries to monitor one another within a

fundamentally anarchic global system. It's alleged that the Five Eyes countries even engage in mutual espionage, bypassing domestic laws by collecting intelligence on each other and sharing it to circumvent legal restrictions.

Despite the inclusion of additional countries in intelligence collaborations after World War II, the alliance retains its original name due to the initial signatories of the UK-US treaty.

The theory that the Five Eyes is intent on destabilizing India's ascent is particularly intriguing. Observers note that, while India has navigated accusations from the U.S. regarding the assassination of Sikh separatist Gurbhag Singh Pannu without significant fallout, Trudeau's handling of the issue has led to strained relations. India has reportedly engaged in diplomatic pragmatism, with National Security Advisor Ajit Doval meeting his Canadian counterpart to discuss long-standing extradition requests.

While some in India focus on the idea of Western powers conspiring against the nation, historical context reveals a complex relationship. During the Cold War, India's strategic mindset was heavily influenced by its ties to the Soviet Union, which has shaped its interactions with Western nations.

PM Modi Inaugurates Eye Hospital In Varanasi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited Varanasi, his Lok Sabha constituency, on Sunday, where he inaugurated the RJ Sankara eye hospital and announced a series of developmental projects totaling ₹6,100 crore. The day-long visit included the laying of the foundation stone for the expansion of the airport runway and the construction of a new terminal at Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport, with an estimated investment of ₹2,870 crore.

Before the hospital's inauguration, PM Modi met with the Shankaracharya of Kanchi Math and visited a local exhibition, accompanied by Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and Governor Anandiben Patel.

Key projects unveiled during his visit aim to enhance infrastructure and connectivity in the region. These include plans for a refurbished terminal at Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport and the establish-



ment of new civil enclaves at Agra, Darbhanga, and Bagdogra airports, with allocations of ₹570 crore, ₹910 crore, and ₹1,550 crore, respectively.

The Prime Minister also announced the inauguration of new terminal buildings at Rewa, Maa Mahamaya,

Ambikapur, and Sarsawa airports, costing over ₹220 crore. These developments are expected to boost passenger handling capacity to more than 2.3 crore annually.

In addition to aviation projects, PM Modi prioritized sports and tourism. He inaugurated phases 2 and 3 of the redevelopment of the Varanasi Sports Complex, valued at ₹210 crore, which will feature a National Centre of Excellence, player accommodations, a sports science center, and various practice fields.

For tourism, initiatives aimed at enhancing the Buddhism pilgrimage in Sarnath were launched, including improvements to pedestrian pathways, sewer systems, and vending zones to support local artisans.

To mark the occasion, over 500 party banners and flags were displayed throughout the city, welcoming PM Modi to Varanasi.



Delhi Blast : AAP's Atishi Blames BJP for Law and Order Issues

In the wake of a mysterious blast in Rohini, Delhi, Chief Minister Atishi has sharply criticized the ruling BJP, emphasizing concerns over the law and order situation in the national capital. The explosion occurred at 7:47 AM, damaging a wall at the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) school in Prashant Vihar. Fortunately, no injuries were reported, but the blast shattered nearby car windows and damaged shop hoardings. A multi-agency investigation is currently underway, involving the Delhi Police Special Cell, the National Investigation Agency (NIA), the CRPF, and the National Security Guard (NSG).

Atishi took to social media platform X to express her concerns, stating that the incident highlights Delhi's "crumbling" law and order system. She pointed out that the Union Home Ministry, which controls the Delhi Police, bears responsibility for the current situation. "The responsibility to maintain law and order in Delhi is with BJP's central government," she argued, adding that the BJP's focus on undermining the elected government has led to a deterioration akin to the lawlessness seen in Mumbai during the Underworld era.

The Chief Minister warned that if the BJP were to gain control of the Delhi government, basic services like hospitals, power, and water supply would suffer, paralleling the current law and order crisis.

In response, BJP leader Shazia Ilmi dismissed Atishi's claims as political posturing. She criticized her for consistently blaming the Centre and urged her to focus on the serious nature of the incident rather than engaging in a blame game. "The situation is totally in control," she stated, emphasizing the need for maturity in addressing such issues.



Infiltrator nabbed, sent back to Bangladesh: Assam CM

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma announced on Sunday that a Bangladeshi national, identified as Mohibulla, was apprehended while illegally entering India in Karimganj district. Following his arrest, Mohibulla was promptly sent back across the border.

In a post on X, Sarma highlighted the incident, stating, "A Bangladeshi infiltrator, Mohibulla, was apprehended near the international border and pushed back across the border in Karimganj." The region is notable for its international border with Bangladesh, spanning 267.5 kilometers across the districts of Karimganj, Cachar, Dhubri, and South Salmara-Mankachar.

The Chief Minister commended the efforts of local law enforcement, saying, "Our forces of @assampolice and @BSF_India are alert 24/7 to thwart all infiltration attempts along the border. Good job Team." This remark underscores the commitment of both the Assam Police and the Border Security Force (BSF) to maintain vigilance and security along the sensitive border.

Karimganj is equipped with an Integrated Check Post (ICP) at Sutarkandi, one of three ICPs in the Northeast, with others located at Dawki in Meghalaya and Akhaura in Tripura. These posts play a crucial role in monitoring and managing border activities.

Assam's Director General of Police, G P Singh, previously emphasized the collaboration between state police and the BSF in preventing illegal crossings from Bangladesh. Singh assured that all necessary measures would be taken to uphold the law and protect national security.

Omar Abdullah Completes 21 km in Kashmir Half Marathon

Omar Abdullah, recently sworn in as the Chief Minister of Jammu and Kashmir, took to the streets for the Kashmir Half Marathon, achieving a personal milestone by completing 21 kilometers. Sharing his excitement on X, he expressed his pride: "I'm so damn pleased with myself today. I completed the Kashmir Half Marathon - 21 KM at an average pace of 5 min 54 sec per KM."

Remarkably, this was Abdullah's first time running more than 13 kilometers, a feat he had accomplished only once before. He credited the energy of fellow amateur runners for his perseverance: "No proper training, no running plan, no nutrition. Picked up a banana & a couple of khajoor along the way." The scenic route around Dal Lake was made even more special as he ran past his home, where family and friends cheered him on.



Throughout the race, the Chief Minister documented his experience, noting the fun atmosphere. "It was such fun running with others. Lots

of selfies & videos along the way. I even had a few requests for appointments and one or two job-related problems highlighted along the way," he shared, highlighting interactions with journalists eager for interviews.

Encouraging others to embrace running as a way to relieve stress, Abdullah stated, "You don't need drugs to feel good or beat stress. A good run, whether a kilometer or a marathon, is enough to clear the cobwebs & achieve a natural feeling of euphoria & enthusiasm. Try it, you won't regret it. Let's start running for a drug-free J&K."

Responding to a participant's concerns about air quality in Delhi, he invited them to experience the fresh air of Kashmir: "Come and run in the Kashmir marathon next time, air quality will be better & the scenery is pretty good too."

BJP Unveils First List of 99 Candidates for Maharashtra Assembly Elections

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has officially announced its first list of 99 candidates for the upcoming Maharashtra assembly elections, with notable figures set to contest in key constituencies. Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis will seek re-election from his stronghold, Nagpur South West, solidifying his position as a crucial player in the party's strategy.

Maharashtra BJP president Chandrashekhar Bawankule has been nominated to contest from Kamthi, while Shriyaya Chavan, daughter of BJP leader and Rajya Sabha MP Ashok Chavan, will stand for election from Bhokar, marking a significant entry into politics for the young candidate.

The list features prominent names including Ashish Shelar, the Mumbai BJP president, who will contest from the Vandre West seat. Manipur Minister Denies Leadership Change Amid Violence

Manipur Minister Th Biswajit Singh has refuted claims regarding a letter purportedly signed by 19 MLAs calling for a change in leadership amidst ongoing violence in the state. This denial comes after leaked excerpts of the alleged letter, which reportedly includes calls for the removal of Chief Minister Biren Singh, surfaced in the media.

Speaking to reporters in Imphal, Singh stated, "I have no knowledge of any such occurrences and I am not an expert to comment on the matter." He added that he could not confirm the validity of the two-page memorandum mentioned in the media, emphasizing his lack of information regarding any leadership transition.

The leaked letter purportedly expresses concern from the 19 BJP MLAs about the Chief Minister's handling of the violence that has plagued Manipur. It highlights the growing dissatisfaction among the public regarding the government's inability to restore peace and normalcy. The MLAs have stated that if a solution is not found soon, they believe the Chief Minister's removal may be the only option.

Among the signatures on the letter were those of Speaker Th Satyabrata, Minister Y Khemchand, and Biswajit Singh. Both Singh and Khemchand have previously been vocal critics of Biren Singh, having called for his resignation on multiple occasions. Satyabrata, however, has been viewed as a loyalist to the Chief Minister.

Do Not Boo, Go: Barack Obama To Trump Supporters At US Election Rally

Former President Barack Obama rallied support for Democrat presidential candidate Kamala Harris and her running mate, Tim Walz, at a public event in Nevada today, sharply criticizing Republican candidate Donald Trump. Obama argued that Trump is primarily concerned with "his ego, money, and status," rather than the needs of the American people.



"We are ready for President Kamala Harris. This is a leader who has dedicated her life to fighting for those in need," Obama stated, emphasizing Harris's background as a middle-class worker and her commitment to the values that underpin the nation. He praised her readiness for the presidency, calling her as prepared as any nominee in history.

In his remarks, Obama also highlighted Walz's qualifications, describing him as a veteran, teacher, and effective governor who collaborates with both Democrats and Republicans. He humorously questioned Trump's practicality, asking if the former president could change a tire without calling for help, contrasting this with Harris and Walz's commitment to addressing the people's problems.

Addressing economic concerns,

Obama acknowledged the struggles many Americans face due to price increases post-COVID-19. He criticized those seeking change by supporting Trump, stating there's no evidence that the former president prioritizes anyone's needs but his own. "Donald Trump is a 78-year-old billionaire who has been complaining about his problems since he first entered politics," Obama remarked, emphasizing Trump's self-serving nature.

He also referenced Trump's controversial merchandise, like the "Trump Bible," humorously noting

its production in China, which contradicts Trump's tough stance on the country. Obama argued that Trump's tactics promote division among Americans, fostering an "us versus them" mentality to boost his electoral chances.

Finally, Obama warned that unchecked power in the hands of someone like Trump could have dire consequences, urging voters to embrace a new chapter in American politics. With the Democrats now rallying behind Harris, he asserted, "America is ready to turn the page. We are ready for a better story."

US Intelligence Documents Leak Reveals Israel's Military Preperation on Iran

Two highly classified US intelligence documents have reportedly leaked, exposing Israel's military preparations for a potential strike on Iran, according to a report by the New York Times. The documents, originating from the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA), which analyzes data from American spy satellites, detail Israeli military exercises and operational readiness.



Dated October 15 and 16, the documents were shared on Telegram by accounts linked to pro-Iran sentiments. They provide insights into Israel's military maneuvers that appear to be geared towards a retaliatory strike against Iran. This escalation follows a missile barrage from Iran on October 1, which was a response to a prior Israeli attack.

One of the leaked documents, titled "Israel: Air Force Continues Preparations for Strike on Iran," outlines recent military exercises that simulate a possible operation against Iran. These preparations reportedly involve air-to-air refueling operations, search-and-rescue missions, and the repositioning of missile systems in anticipation of Iranian responses. The second document highlights Israel's logistical efforts to relocate munitions and military assets to strategic locations.

While the documents offer a glimpse into Israeli military activities, they do not include actual satellite images. US intelligence

suggests that Israel is indeed preparing for a strike, but the documents may not reveal the complete scope of Israel's operational plans.

The leaks have raised immediate concerns within the US government. Officials are split on the severity of the situation; some believe the leak is less impactful as it does not unveil new American capabilities, while others worry about the exposure of sensitive Israeli military strategies during a time of heightened tensions in the Middle East.

When questioned during a recent trip to Germany about his awareness of Israel's plans, President Joe Biden affirmed, "Yes and yes," but refrained from providing further details. The source of the leak remains uncertain, with early indications suggesting it may involve a lower-level US government employee. A joint investigation by the Pentagon, US intelligence agencies, and the FBI is underway to determine the leak's origins and the potential for further disclosures.



Kamala Harris Sparks Backlash with Campaign Ad Targeting Black Male Voters'

As Kamala Harris intensifies her efforts to engage Black voters ahead of next month's presidential election, her campaign has come under fire for a new digital ad that has sparked controversy regarding its portrayal of Black men's love lives. The ad, released following former President Barack Obama's comments about the need for Black male voter support, aims to resonate with young voters through a dating game format.

Promoted on platforms like Instagram and Snapchat, the ad features a male character being quizzed by a group of women about his height, income, and workout routine. The interaction takes a turn when one woman asks if he has a "plan to vote." Despite positive responses to the earlier questions, the man admits, "Uh, I didn't plan on it." The screen then flashes a caption urging viewers, "Don't get popped. Vote. Election Day is November 5," along with a note that the ad is paid for by Harris for President.

While intended to encourage voter turnout, the advertisement has attracted significant criticism online, particularly for its implications about Black men and their voting habits. Some users on X (formerly Twitter) expressed their disapproval, with one commenting, "Wow. I don't know what to say. Screams desperate." Others mocked the campaign's strategy, highlighting that approximately 65% of the ad spending was directed towards women, suggesting a misalignment with the target demographic.

The ad has also been screened at university campuses in battleground states like Arizona, where young voters are crucial. However, the backlash raises questions about the effectiveness of the campaign's approach to reaching Black male voters, a demographic that has shown varying levels of support for Harris.

As the election date approaches, the Harris campaign will need to navigate these criticisms and refine its messaging to foster a broader connection with the Black community, particularly among young Black men, in a landscape that remains increasingly competitive.

Hezbollah Deputy Chief Naim Qassem Flees Lebanon Amid Assassination Fears

Naim Qassem, the deputy secretary general of Hezbollah, has reportedly fled Lebanon due to safety concerns and is currently residing in Tehran, according to local media sources. This move comes amid fears that Qassem could become a target for assassination by the Israeli government.



According to a report by UAE-based Erem News, Qassem left Beirut on October 5 on an aircraft associated with Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi during his state visit to Lebanon and Syria. The decision to relocate him was made by top leaders of the Islamic Republic, citing assassination risks.

Qassem, who has recently emerged as Hezbollah's top official following the death of its chief, Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah, in an Israeli strike, has been vocal about the need for a ceasefire in the

ongoing conflict. He has warned that Hezbollah would not be defeated and emphasized the group's right to retaliate against Israeli targets across the region.

In recent speeches, Qassem has sup-

ported efforts by Lebanese parliament speaker Nabih Berri to broker a ceasefire without preconditions, marking a shift from previous demands that the end of the Gaza conflict be a prerequisite for halting hostilities in Lebanon. He stated, "The solution is a ceasefire... the resistance [Hezbollah] will not be defeated because this is its land."

The conflict between Israel and Hezbollah has intensified in recent weeks, resulting in significant casualties and displacing over a million people in Lebanon. Qassem's departure underscores the heightened tensions and the potential for further escalation in the region.

As the situation develops, Qassem's role and statements will likely continue to be pivotal in shaping Hezbollah's response to the ongoing conflict and its strategies moving forward.

Pakistan Cabinet Approves Controversial 26th Constitutional Amendment

The Pakistan Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, has approved the draft of the contentious 26th Constitutional Amendment, paving the way for its presentation in both the Senate and National Assembly. This decision follows extensive discussions with coalition partners, including the Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP).

During a meeting with President Asif Ali Zardari, Prime Minister Sharif provided a detailed briefing on the proposed amendment. Federal Minister Musadik Malik confirmed that the draft was collaboratively prepared with input from coalition partners. The cabinet's endorsement marks a significant step towards the amendment's parliamentary consideration.



The government is optimistic about securing passage for the amendment, which has been a subject of speculation regarding its intent to dilute the powers of an independent judiciary. Reports suggest that the amendment may involve raising the retirement age for judges and establishing fixed tenures for the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

The legislative process is set to be closely monitored, with sessions scheduled for both houses of parliament. Security measures have been heightened, and access for guests has been restricted. Recent discussions with key coalition figures, including Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam-Fazl (JUI-F) chief Maulana Fazlur Rehman, indicate a concerted effort to garner the necessary support.

Canadian Police: No Immediate Threat Amid India-Canada Tensions

Canadian police officials have stated that there is "no imminent threat" to the public from a "network of criminals" operating within Canada, following recent tensions stemming from allegations against the Indian government regarding the assassination of pro-Khalistan activist Hardeep Singh Nijjar. This announcement was made during an interview broadcast on October 20 by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (CBC).



The remarks come in the wake of Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's government publicly accusing agents of the Indian government of involvement in Nijjar's shooting, which has intensified diplomatic strains between the two nations. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) had previously asserted that these agents were linked to various acts of violence, including homicides in Canada. RCMP Assistant Commissioner Brigitte Gauvin clarified that the agency had undertaken numerous efforts before making these claims public, including sharing evidence with Indian authorities and holding discussions between senior officials from both countries. However, these efforts reportedly did not yield any cooperation.

Gauvin emphasized during the interview that the RCMP's public announcement was not prompted by an immediate threat, referring to a surprise press conference held on October 14.

India's Automobile Exports Surge 14% in First Half of Fiscal Year



India's automobile exports have shown a robust 14% increase in the first six months of the current fiscal year, buoyed by significant gains in passenger vehicle and two-wheeler shipments. According to data from the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM), total exports reached 2,528,248 units from April to September, compared

to 2,211,457 units during the same period last year.

Shailesh Chandra, President of SIAM, attributed this rebound in vehicle exports to the recovery of key markets, particularly in Latin America and Africa, which had previously experienced slowdowns. "This has been the main reason for exports coming back," Chan-

dra noted, highlighting how the devaluation of currencies in several African nations had earlier constrained vehicle shipments as these countries prioritized essential imports.

The overall export performance reflects a significant contrast to the previous fiscal year's challenges, where automobile exports had dipped by 5.5%, primarily due to monetary crises in various international markets. In FY24, total automobile exports stood at 4,500,492 units, a decline from 4,761,299 units in FY23.

Passenger vehicle exports rose by 12% year-on-year to 376,679 units in the first half of this fiscal year, up from 336,754 units during the same quarter last year. Maruti Suzuki

emerged as the leader in this segment, exporting 147,063 units, marking a 12% increase from 131,546 units the previous year. Hyundai Motor India, on the other hand, saw a slight decline, exporting 84,900 units, down 1% from 86,105 units in the previous fiscal year. Two-wheeler exports also experienced a notable rise, increasing 16% to 1,959,145 units compared to 1,685,907 units a year earlier. Within this category, scooter exports grew by 19% to 314,533 units, while motorcycle exports increased by 16% to 1,641,804 units.

Conversely, commercial vehicle exports rose by 12% to 35,731 units, while three-wheeler shipments saw a slight decline of 1% to 153,199 units during the same period.



RBI Lifts Restrictions on Financial Products Against Shares and Debentures

JM Financial announced on Friday that the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has lifted the restrictions imposed on its subsidiary, JM Financial Products Ltd (JMFPL), concerning financing against shares and debentures. This decision follows the RBI's previous order dated March 5, 2024, which had prohibited JMFPL from providing loans against these financial instruments.

In a regulatory filing, JM Financial stated, "We wish to inform you that the RBI, via its letter dated October 18, 2024, has removed the restrictions imposed on JM Financial Products Ltd." With this development, JMFPL is now authorized to engage in financing activities related to shares and debentures, effective immediately, provided they comply with all applicable laws and regulations.

The earlier restrictions had significant implications for JMFPL's operations, especially as it curtailed the company's ability to sanction loans for initial public offerings (IPOs) and other related financial services. The lifting of these restrictions signals a renewed operational capacity for JM Financial, allowing them to resume lending activities that are crucial for facilitating investments and liquidity in the market.

This change comes at a time when the demand for financial products linked to equities and corporate bonds is witnessing an upward trend. Analysts view the RBI's decision as a positive step for JM Financial, enabling the firm to capitalize on opportunities in the financial market while providing essential services to investors.

JM Financial's proactive approach and compliance with regulatory requirements appear to have played a role in this favorable outcome. As the company re-establishes its financing capabilities, it is expected to enhance its service offerings and support market participants looking to navigate the complexities of share and debenture financing.

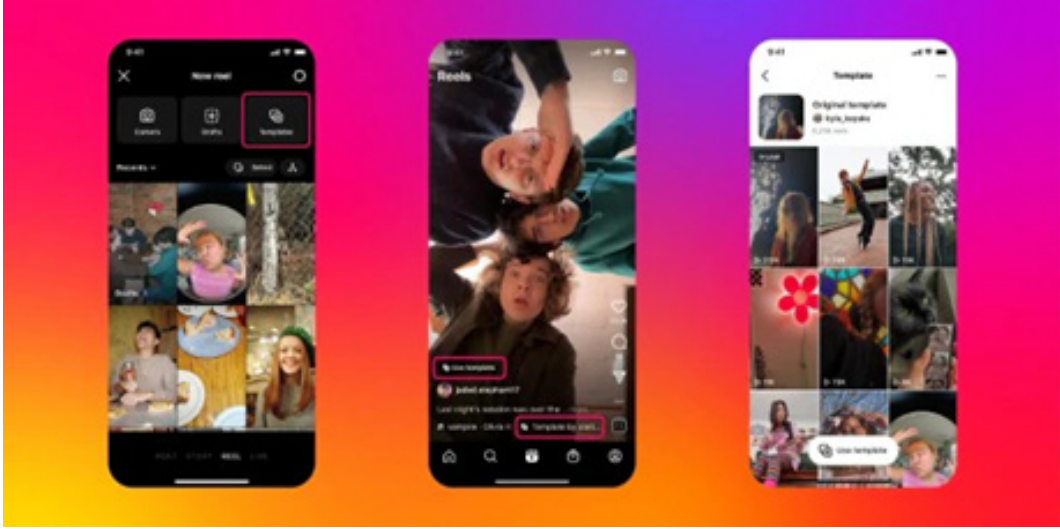

Harry Kane's Hat-Trick Propels Bayern Munich Back to the Top

Bayern Munich sporting director Max Eberl hailed striker Harry Kane as a "killer" after his stunning 23-minute hat-trick secured a commanding 4-0 victory over Stuttgart on Saturday. 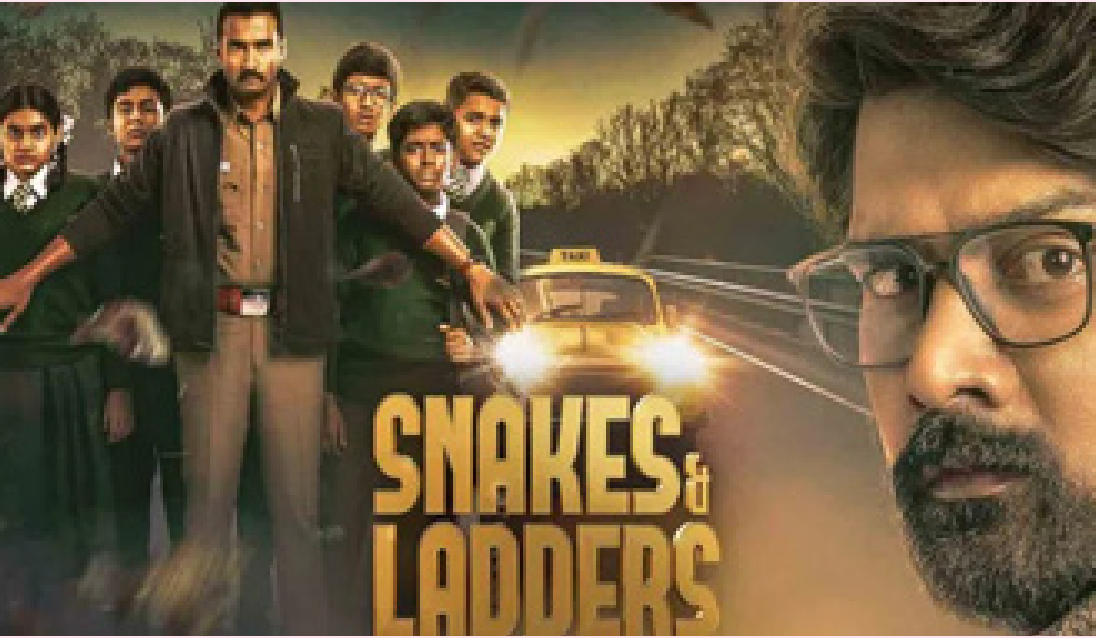
