YSR Family Rift Deepens as Jagan Takes Legal Action Against Sister Sharmila

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The political landscape in Andhra Pradesh has taken a dramatic turn as YSR Congress Party (YS-RCP) president YS Jagan Mohan Reddy has filed a petition with the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) against his sister YS Sharmila and mother YS Vijayamma. The petition seeks to nullify what Jagan describes as the "illegal" transfer of shares in Saraswati Power and Industries Private Limited to Sharmila and Vijayamma. Jagan and his wife, Bharathi Reddy, allege that the transfers, executed through a Board resolution in July 2024, violated legal procedures.

In their petition, filed on September 10, Jagan and Bharathi request the company rectify its register and reinstate them as shareholders with the same equity shares they held prior to the contested transfers. They assert that Sharmila's actions have caused "deep disrepute" to Jagan, highlighting the family tensions that have escalated since Sharmila left YS-RCP to form her own party, YSR Telangana Party, in 2021. Compounding the situation, Sharmila's party merged with the Congress in January 2024, positioning her as a vocal opponent of Jagan in the recent Andhra Pradesh Assembly elections.

The petition alleges that the transfers were made without the submission of duly executed share transfer forms or original certificates, violating Section 56 of the Companies Act of 2013. It also references a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) established in August 2019, which Jagan claims was intended to transfer certain wonder why there should be any love and

Jagan's petition underscores the emotional rift between the siblings, stating, "Respondent no. 2 [Sharmila], without gratitude and without regard to the well-being of the Applicant no. 1 [Jagan], conducted a series of actions that deeply hurt Petitioner no. 1." He further expresses that Sharmila's public statements and political opposition have strained their relationship, leading him to withdraw his previous intention to transfer shares as outlined in the MoU.

In a letter sent to Sharmila on August 27, Jagan reiterated his past support, claiming to have provided approximately ₹200 crores over the last decade out of love for her. However, he expressed disillusionactions undertaken by you, it makes me deeply personal conflict.

Sharmila responded to Jagan's letter on September 12, defending her position and arguing that their late father, YS Rajasekhara Reddy, intended for all four of his grandchildren to share equally in family assets. She accused Jagan of not honoring their father's wishes and criticized his attempts to control her political career.

As the dispute intensifies, the NCLT has issued notices to all respondents, with a hearing scheduled for November 8. The ongoing family feud not only highlights personal animosities but also reflects broader political implications as both siblings navigate their roles in Andhra Pradesh's political arena. AP Cabinet Approves 3 Free Gas Cylinders Per Year



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a significant move, the Andhra Pradesh Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, has approved the provision of three free gas cylinders per year starting from Diwali. The scheme ensures that individuals purchasing gas cylinders will receive the equivalent amount deposited into their accounts within 48 hours. This initiative is expected to cost the government Rs 2,700 crore annually.

Another major decision made during the Cabinet meeting was the revocation of the 15-acre land allotment previously granted to Sarada Peetha in Visakhapatnam under the Jagan administration. Additionally, the Cabinet has given its nod to a number of other key reforms, including the removal of scenic and GST charges under the free sand policy. It also approved the extraction of sand from private lands (Patta lands) and an amendment to increase the number of members in temple committees across the state.

The meeting was attended by the Chief Secretary, Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, Ministers, and various officials. These decisions reflect the government's ongoing commitment to providing relief and benefits to the public, especially through the free gas cylinder scheme, and to ensure greater transparency in resource management.

Jagan Sensational Comments on Law and Order in Andhra Pradesh

Conditions Are Dirty in the state... Red Book Rule is in Effect



TPN, **Andhra Pradesh**: Former Chief Minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy made a series of sensational comments about the deteriorating law and order situation in Andhra Pradesh, while also criticizing the current NDA government for neglecting women's welfare schemes introduced during his tenure. Jagan's remarks came after he visited the family of Sahana, a young woman who was declared brain-dead following an assault in Guntur.

Speaking to the media, Jagan expressed outrage at the rising violence against women in the state, specifically pointing out the tragic death of a Dalit woman. He emphasized that during his rule under the YCP government, initiatives like the Disha app were launched to ensure the safety of women, allowing immediate police response through an SOS feature. He accused the present government of turning a blind eye to such incidents, especially when the accused had ties to the ruling party.

Jagan further criticized the state's handling of



the Sahana case, alleging that no government officials visited the victim's family or offered compensation. He claimed the accused was associated with TDP leaders, including CM Chandrababu Naidu, and was being shielded from legal consequences.

In his address, Jagan also questioned why prominent leaders like Pawan Kalyan and Nandamuri Balakrishna had not visited victims of such heinous crimes. He listed several other incidents, including the rape of a minor in Pithapuram and a gang-rape in Hindupur, pointing out the lack of action and support from the government and local leaders.

Jagan stressed that under YCP's rule, significant strides were made for women's safety, with the introduction of people's courts, Disha vehicles, and the Disha app, which won 19 national awards. He condemned the current regime for dismantling these schemes and failing to protect





Minister Anagani Satyaprasad Responds to Jagan's Comments on Law and Order

Jagan You Don't Have Right to talk About On Law and Order

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Minister Anagani Satyaprasad gave a sharp rebuttal to former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's remarks on the state's law and order situation. Addressing the media on Wednesday, Satyaprasad criticized Jagan for raising concerns, particularly when over two lakh cases were registered during his own tenure.

Satyaprasad accused Jagan of acting irresponsibly after his electoral defeat, alleging that he was attempting to tarnish the image of the coalition government. The Minister questioned the former Chief Minister's record, pointing to numerous incidents of violence against women that occurred during

his rule. He highlighted that, despite over two lakh registered cases, there was little effective action taken under Jagan's administration to curb such incidents.

The Minister also mentioned specific cases, such as the gang rape of a Dalit girl near Jagan's residence, where the accused, Venkata Reddy, remained free for five years. He remarked that Jagan's failure to act in these cases undermined his credibility in speaking about law and order. Satyaprasad further criticized Jagan for his inability to control the spread of ganja, drugs, and illicit liquor during his rule, which he claimed led to a rise in violent incidents, including attacks on women.



He defended the coalition government's approach, asserting that they have been taking immediate and strict action against perpetrators, irrespective of their political or social background. He emphasized that the government is committed to punishing offenders and maintaining law and order.

In contrast, Jagan, during a visit to Guntur, had earlier accused the current administration of failing to protect women, criticizing them for canceling key initiatives like the Disha app, which provided quick police response for women in distress. He alleged that the current government was politicizing crimes and shielding perpetrators based on their political affiliations.

Home Minister Anitha Slams Jagan for Family Dispute and Time-Pass Politics


Amaravati Drone Summit-2024 Concludes Successfully, A Leap Towards Drone Innovation

MLA Galla Madhavi Slams Jagan for Politicizing Tragedies



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: MLA Galla Madhavi has launched a strong attack on former Chief Minister and YSR Congress Party (YCP) leader Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, accusing him of exploiting tragic incidents for political gain. Chintamohan Bold Remarks, Polavaram and **Amaravati Will Take Another Century to Complete**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former Union Minister and senior Congress leader Chintamohan made striking statements during a press conference in Vijayawada on Wednesday. Addressing the ongoing Polavaram and Amaravati projects, he claimed that both would not be completed for another hundred years.

Chintamohan shared his findings from a recent visit to Hyderabad, where he met a senior official who had served under four Chief Ministers. According to this official, the completion of the Polavaram project requires the relocation of 30 lakh tribals, an immense challenge. Furthermore, Chintamohan expressed doubt about the contractors' abilities, claiming that no local companies have the capacity to construct the project, and even if they manage, it might collapse. He asserted that only three companies in the world — from China, the United States, and Germany — are capable of successfully completing Polavaram.

He criticized the handling of Polavaram, describing it as a "Dhanayajna" (a cash bonanza for politicians) rather than the intended "Jala Yajna" (a water project). Chintamohan also questioned the progress of Amaravati, drawing a parallel with Delhi, which took years to become a metropolis after being de-



clared the capital in 1905.

Chintamohan took jabs at Chandrababu Naidu, remarking that despite his long experience as Chief Minister, Naidu's continuous Chintamohan concluded by stressing the urfocus on Amaravati and Polavaram has not yielded much progress. He further mocked political distractions, such as the recent addressing unemployment, reducing taxes, drone and Laddu incidents.

In his critique of India's current political scenario, Chintamohan advocated for a return to ballot-based elections, arguing that the ruling BJP manipulates EVMs in regions where the opposition is weak. He

Vasireddy Padma Resigns from YCP, Criticizes Jagan's Leadership

Urgent Call to Address Fraudulent Activities in AP Football Association

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: We, the founding members of the Andhra Pradesh Football Association (APFA), wish to bring to your attention the alarming issue of corruption and manipulation within the promotion of sports in our state, particularly regarding the recent activities of Kotagiri Sridhar, former MP, and Daniel Pradeep, former member of the Sports Authority of Andhra Pradesh (SAAP).

Six individuals affiliated with Kotagiri Sridhar are members of multiple district football associations, as well as the state-level Andhra Pradesh Football Federation. The All India Football Federation (AIFF) has issued two letters dated 14.04.2022 and 27.04.2022, clearly stating that Kotagiri Sridhar is not a recognized member of the Andhra Pradesh Football Association and has misused his position as MP to arrange illegal meetings in Tirupati.

Minister Nadendla Manohar on Free Gas Cylinder Distribution Scheme



TPN, Vijayawada: In line with the "Super 6" schemes promised in the joint manifesto, State Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar announced the launch of a free gas cylinder distribution program, set to commence on October 31, during the Diwali festival. Under this scheme, three free LPG cylinders will be provided to eligible families, with an annual expenditure of Rs. 2,684 crores by the government.

Key Highlights:

- Three cylinders annually will be distributed to each eligible family in three block periods: - April to July
- August to November
- December to March
- The cost of each gas cylinder, Rs. 894.92, will be fully subsidized, with the subsidy amount credited directly to beneficiaries' bank accounts via Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) within 48 hours of delivery.
- Cylinder booking will open three days before distribution begins, and the government aims to deliver the cylinders to all eligible households on the same day.
- The government has secured agreements

with three gas companies to ensure smooth implementation of the scheme despite financial challenges.

- To address any issues, a grievance redressal system will be set up at village and ward secretariats to resolve problems quickly, following instructions from the Chief Minister.

Minister Nadendla Manohar emphasized that the government is committed to making this program available to every household, ensuring timely delivery and efficient

Minister Kollu Ravindra Announces Reforms in Sand Mining Policy

TPN, Vijayawada: State Mines, Geology & Excise Minister Kollu Ravindra emphasized that the previous government had exploited sand mining without any regulation, driving up prices and burdening both the construction sector and the public. He criticized the former rulers for cutting deep into the riverbeds and increasing the cost of sand, which hindered infrastructure development.

In contrast, Minister Ravindra highlighted the coalition government's efforts to make sand accessible to the public without additional financial burden. In line with the election promise, a free sand policy was introduced, under which sand is made available at stock points with only the charges for handling and loading to be paid by the people. However, due to heavy rains since June



and flooding in the Krishna and Godavari rivers, sand extraction was affected.

To address the shortages, the government has authorized 108 new sand reaches in addition to existing ones. These efforts, along with reforms in the sand policy, are expected to boost availability and prevent illegal activities ter Ravindra assured that these reforms will benefit around 30 lakh construction workers, directly impacting the construction sector positively.

Key reforms include:

Fee waivers for DMF, MERIT, and handling charges, removing up to ₹100 per ton that was previously paid by the public.

Residents of riverside villages can transport sand free of cost by booking directly through village secretariats or the online portal. To prevent black marketing and illegal sand transportation, both online and offline registration systems will be implemented for transparency.

GPS tracking for all vehicles carrying sand to detect violations, with penalties including vehicle seizure, blacklisting, and crimi-

Massive Corruption Uncovered in Transfer Orders of Secretariat Employees



TPN, Ongole: A shocking investigation has revealed significant irregularities in the transfer orders of Grade-5 and Grade-6 employees under the Zilla Panchayat, raising serious concerns about corruption within the system. The inquiry, led by a three-member committee chaired by Forest Settlement Officer Lokeswara Rao, has exposed allegations of bribery and misconduct during the transfer process.

The committee has been actively collecting evidence over the past two days, interviewing transferred employees and gathering details about the alleged corrupt practices. Reports indicate that substantial sums of money were exchanged, with payments being made through digital platforms such as PhonePay and GooglePay. These transactions appear to have been facilitated by secretar- supposed to be overseeing the process. ies of the Secretariat, who allegedly worked to secure their transfer orders On the second day of the inquiry, through questionable means.

Witnesses have claimed that payments were made to the family members of former District Panchavat Officer Usharani, suggesting that the corruption may be deeply rooted. While Usharani defended her integrity, stating she acted honestly and had no involvement in the alleged misconduct, investigators have pointed to bank transactions that contradict her The situation escalated when it was claims.

The inquiry revealed that some employees had written statements detailing their fear of speaking out during the investigation. As a result, written information was collected to document the irregularities. Furthermore, secretariat employees reported that they were compelled to pay bribes to the investigators who were

Employees from various positions within the Zilla Panchayat office were questioned, and many reported paying money to obtain their transfer orders. One employee claimed they only received their order after completing a payment through PhonePay.

In a broader context, the inquiry has uncovered a troubling pattern of corruption and misconduct within the Zilla Panchayat, with allegations of previous District Panchayat Officers accepting bribes in exchange for favorable reports. The DLDO of Markapuram was recently suspended following accusations of harassment towards a female employee, with reports indicating that ₹50,000 was solicited to ensure a favorable outcome in the investigation.

As the inquiry continues, the committee is expected to submit a comprehensive report to the Collector, which may reveal further names and actions involved in this significant corruption scandal. The outcome of this investigation could have lasting implications for those involved and the integrity of the Zilla Panchayat system.

Delhi's Air Pollution Crisis: Blame Game and Short-Term Solutions

With Delhi's Air Quality Index (AQI) soaring to 310, categorizing it as "very poor," the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) has implemented the Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) Stage II. This stage includes banning the use of coal and firewood, particularly in restaurants and open eateries, as well as diesel generator sets, except for emergencies. Fireworks have also been prohibited, a measure particularly relevant as Diwali approaches.

Delhi Chief Minister Atishi wasted no time in blaming neighboring states for the city's deteriorating air quality. She accused the BJP of "dirty politics," claiming that rising pollution levels are primarily due to stubble burning in states like Haryana and Uttar Pradesh, while downplaying Punjab's role, where her party governs. Atishi cited data from the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) showing a drop in stubble

burning in Punjab but an increase in Haryana and Uttar Pradesh.

However, experts have contested her claims, arguing that smoke from Uttar Pradesh is unlikely to affect Delhi's air quality due to prevailing wind patterns. Stubble fire fumes typically move in a north-west to south-east direction, making it improbable for emissions from Uttar Pradesh to reach the capital. The Uttar Pradesh government has also highlighted a significant reduction in stubble burning incidents over the past seven years, further challenging Atishi's narrative.

In contrast, Punjab's progress in addressing stubble burning remains lackluster. While the Centre has sanctioned numerous Compressed Biogas (CBG) plants in the state, only a handful are operational. Without effective processing facilities for agricultural waste, the issue of stubble burning will persist, undermining efforts to improve air

In a heartfelt address at a public meeting in Wayanad, Kerala, Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra emphasized the significance of her candidacy as she prepares to contest the upcoming by-election for the parliamentary seat. Surrounded by her mother, Sonia Gandhi, and brother, Rahul Gandhi, Priyanka shared that although she has been campaigning for 35 years, this is the first time she is seeking support for herself.

Reflecting on her long history in politics, she recalled starting her campaign journey at just 17, working for her father, former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi, and subsequently for her mother and brother. "It is a very different feeling," she remarked, expressing gratitude to Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge for the opportunity to run. "It will be my honour to represent you if you give me a chance," she added, highlighting her commitment to the constituency.

During her speech, Priyanka spoke about her recent visits to areas affected by devastating landslides that resulted in significant loss of life and property. "I saw the devastation with my own eyes. I met mothers who lost their children and people whose entire lives were washed away," she said, emphasizing the resilience and compassion of the community. "Each and every person I met was engaged in helping each other," she noted, underlining the spirit of solidarity she witnessed.

Rahul Gandhi, the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, also addressed the gathering, expressing his deep appreciation for Wayanad. He assured the constituents that they would have both an official MP and an unofficial MP in Lok Sabha, both dedicated to raising their is-



Congress, Uddhav Sena, Sharad Pawar's Party To Contest 85 Seats

The Shiv Sena faction led by tra elections, confirming that seat-sharing negotiations within the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) coalition have reached a conclusion. After weeks of intense discussions, it was agreed that each of the three main allies—Shiv Sena UBT, Congress, and Sharad Pawar's Nationalist Congress Party (NCP)—will contest 85 seats, totaling 255 seats. The remaining 33 seats in the state's 288-seat assembly will be allocated to smaller allied parties.

Nana Patole shared the finalized formula. Raut indicated that Sharad Pawar had instructed them to communicate the 85-85-85 arrangement to the media. However, questions arose when the math didn't seem to add up, as 85 seats per party would only total 255, not the 270 mentioned by Raut. When confronted with this discrepancy, Shiv Sena's Anil Desai attempted to clarify, saying that the seat allocation for smaller parties

> The MVA allies had a lengthy six-hour meeting that extended past midnight before resuming discussions the following morning. Veteran leader Sharad Pawar played a crucial role in mediating between Congress and Shiv Sena UBT, which had encountered a stalemate over a few contested seats, particularly in Mumbai, Nashik, and Vidarbha.

West Bengal Prepares for Impending Cyclone, Closes Schools

Banerjee announced comprehensive measures in response to an impending cyclone, which is expected to impact the state between October 25 and 26. As a precautionary step, educational institutions and Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) centers in nine districts will remain closed starting Wednesday. This announcement comes as the India Meteorological Department (IMD) indicated that a low-pressure area over the Bay of Bengal has intensified into a depression, with predictions of it evolving into a severe cyclonic storm.

At a media briefing, Banerjee emphasized that the state administration is fully prepared to tackle the cyclone. She noted that integrated control rooms at both state and district levels are operational 24/7. "Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the seas, and public address systems have been set up in coastal areas to keep residents informed," she stated.

The IMD has predicted that the cy-

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata clone will likely make landfall between Puri and Sagar Island, with wind speeds potentially reaching 110-120 km/h. "The districts of South and North 24 Parganas, Purba Medinipur, and their coastal areas are expected to face severe impacts," she said. Other districts such as Paschim Medinipur, Bankura, Jhargram, and Hooghly will also be affected, prompting school closures from October 23 to 26.

> Banerjee directed district administrations to evacuate residents from low-lying areas to safer locations. Ferry services along the coast have been suspended, and tourist movements are being closely monitored. "We do not want to take any risks with people's safety. Schools and colleges can serve as shelters if necessary," she added. To ensure effective coordination, Chief Secretary Manoj Pant convened a meeting with various departments, including the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and State Disaster Response Force (SDRF).

Stalin Challenges Palaniswami **Amid DMK's Rising Popularity**

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin on Tuesday took a jab at Leader of the Opposition Edappadi K. Palaniswami, sarcastically questioning whether he was living in a "dream land" to overlook the realities of the state's political landscape. Stalin accused Palaniswami of waging a misinformation campaign regarding the DMK's increasing popularity among the public.

Speaking after laying the foundation stones for 140 new projects worth ₹366 crore in Namakkal district, as well as inaugurating 134 completed projects valued at ₹298 crore, Stalin expressed confidence that the DMK would once again defeat the AIADMK in the 2026 assembly elections. He stated, "The electoral results of the last five years clearly indicate that the AIADMK is heading for another crushing defeat."

During his address at Bommakuttaimedu along the Namakkal-Salem national highway, Stalin pointed out that the DMK's influence had grown significantly since the recent Lok Sabha elections, surpassing the level observed during the 2021 Assembly elections. He asserted that Palaniswami's remarks about the DMK's declining respect were unfounded. "Is the Leader of the Opposition in this world or in a dream world?" he questioned, suggesting Palaniswami should interact with the women who regularly use government buses to see their relief firsthand. Stalin highlighted various welfare initiatives, such as the monthly ₹1,000 grants to over one crore women and the free breakfast scheme benefiting 20 lakh children. He stated that these programs have garnered positive feedback from the populace, reinforcing the DMK's reputation.

Congress Questions India-China Agreement on Patrolling Rights

Ahead of a pivotal bilateral meeting between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chinese President Xi Jinping at the BRICS Summit in Kazan, the Congress party has raised significant concerns regarding the recent agreement on patrolling arrangements along the Line of Actual Control (LAC). The agreement aims to restore mutual patrolling rights in contentious areas such as the Depsang Plains and the Demchok region, which are characterized by legacy issues predating the 2020 incursions by China.

The Congress has demanded transparency from the government, urging it to take the Indian populace into confidence regarding the details of this agreement. They emphasized the need for clarity on how this arrangement might affect national security and border integrity. Congress leaders have posed several questions aimed at understanding the implications of this decision, particularly given the complex historical context of India-China relations and the ongoing tensions that have marked recent years. In their statements, Congress leaders have highlighted that the restoration of patrolling rights must not compromise India's sovereignty or strategic interests.







Border Peace, Mutual Trust And Respect Should Be Priority': PM Modi To Xi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is between the two nations. scheduled to meet with Chinese President Xi Jinping for a bilateral discussion on the sidelines of the BRICS summit in Russia, marking their first formal engagement since the 2020 Galwan Valley clash. Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri confirmed the meeting, emphasizing its significance in light of recent developments in India-China relations, particularly regarding a new consensus on patrolling arrangements along the Line of Actual Control (LAC).

Misri stated, "I can confirm that there will be a bilateral meeting held between Prime Minister Modi and Chinese President Xi Jinping tomorrow on the sidelines of the BRICS Summit," as reported by news agency ANI. This meeting comes amid growing speculation about a thaw in relations

Since the tensions that erupted following the Galwan clash on June 15, 2020, there have been limited interactions between Modi and Xi. Notably, they exchanged pleasantries during the G20 summit in Bali, Indonesia, in November 2022 and at the BRICS summit in Johannesburg, South Africa, in August 2023. Both leaders are currently in Kazan, Russia, where they will also meet with Russian President Vladimir Putin and South Africa's Cyril Ramaphosa.

The anticipated breakthrough in patrolling arrangements signals a potential de-escalation of tensions, which have seen both countries amass tens of thousands of troops along their shared border. The new agreement suggests a return to pre2020 protocols, aiming to stabilize the situation and foster confidence-building measures between New Delhi and Beijing.

The Galwan clash had significant repercussions, leading to strained diplomatic ties and casualties on both sides. While a gradual de-escalation has occurred since then, a complete return to pre-Galwan conditions has remained elusive. This ongoing tension has also impacted various areas of bilateral interaction, including the suspension of direct flights for four years and heightened scrutiny of Chinese technicians' visas.

As Modi and Xi prepare for this pivotal meeting, the world watches closely for indications of a shift towards improved relations between the two Asian giants.



representing Japan's ruling Liberal Democratic Party (LDP) in her 20-seat prefecture for the upcoming general election on October 27. Her candidacy highlights the challenges women face in Japan's male-dominated political landscape. Despite the LDP's commitment to narrowing the significant gender gap among lawmakers, the party has fallen short of its target to achieve 35% female candidates in the lower house by 2025, with only 16% of its candidates being women in this election.

Surveys indicate that societal attitudes pose significant barriers for female candidates. Many believe that the LDP, which has held power for most of Japan's post-war history, lacks genuine commitment to gender equality, often failing to implement meaningful measures to improve the situation. In contrast, the opposition Constitutional Democratic Party of Japan (CDPJ) boasts a slightly higher percentage of female candidates at 22%.

As Makishima campaigns in her coastal constituency of Odawara, she articulates the struggles women face, noting, "The biggest drawback of having a low number of female legislators is that it doesn't change traditional perceptions, such as that women are not suited to politics."

Japan's gender gap remains a significant issue, with just over 10% of lawmakers in the lower house being female, compared to an average of 30% in other G7 nations. This disparity has drawn international criticism, particularly as Japan ranks 118th out of 146 countries in the World Economic Forum's gender gap

Although the LDP has set a target of 30% female lawmakers by 2033, experts argue that the party requires more concrete plans, such as gender quotas, to make real progress. Some lawmakers, like former defense minister Tomomi Inada, advocate for a detailed strategy to achieve these goals.



Delhi Can Play A Part: Iran President Meets PM Modi Over West Asia Crisis

Asia, Prime Minister Narendra Modi met with Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian on the sidelines of In their bilateral talks, Modi and the BRICS summit in Kazan, Russia. This meeting is particularly significant as it comes during a period of heightened conflict, including the ongoing Israel-Hamas war and the Israel-Hezbollah tensions, alongside recent Iranian missile threats against Israel.

India has expressed "deep concern' regarding the situation and has consistently advocated for "dialogue and diplomacy" to alleviate tensions in the region. During their discussion, both leaders recognized the importance of peace in West Asia, with President Pezeshkian underscoring India's potential role in de-escalating the crisis due to its amicable relations with all parties involved.

India's unique diplomatic position allows it to mediate between Israel and Iran, with Modi recently having spoken to Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and now engaging with President Pezeshkian. This is not an isolated instance, as Modi is also actively seeking to broker peace between Russia and Ukraine, maintaining strong ties with both Vladi-

Amid escalating tensions in West mir Putin and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy.

> Pezeshkian discussed enhancing India-Iran relations, focusing on strategic projects like the Chabahar Port and the International North-South Transport Corridor (INSTC). After their meeting, Modi expressed optimism about their discussions, highlighting the historical and civilizational ties between the two nations.

> The Indian Ministry of External Affairs reported that the leaders discussed the need for protecting civilians amidst the ongoing conflict in West Asia, reinforcing their commitment to peace and stability in the region. Pezeshkian acknowledged India's role in Iran's participation in international forums like the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) and BRICS, indicating a collaborative future.

> Modi extended an invitation for Pezeshkian to visit India soon, which the Iranian president accepted. This meeting marks the first engagement between the two leaders since Pezeshkian took office in July, following the tragic death of his predecessor, Ebrahim Raisi.



US "Absolutely" Ready For First Woman President: Kamala Harris

The vibrant atmosphere at Howard University's homecoming parade was a testament to the enduring legacy of the historically Black college (HBCU) and its most famous alumna, Vice President Kamala Harris. With the U.S. presidential election approaching, Harris faces a critical challenge: retaining support from Black voters, a demographic essential for Democratic success.

Recent polls, including a New York

Times/Siena survey, indicate a worrying trend for Harris, revealing that her support among Black voters has dropped to 78%, significantly lower than the 90% backing President Joe Biden enjoyed against Donald Trump four years ago. This shift has raised alarms, particularly as Trump has made inroads among traditionally Democratic Black voters, especially men. At Howard's festivities, however, there were signs of strong support for Harris. Vendors sold campaign merchandise, and attendees took photos with cutouts of the vice president. Kacy Haynes, visiting from Louisiana, noted he hadn't encountered much pro-Trump sentiment during the celebrations. Despite Trump's attempts to engage with Black communities, analysts argue that the overall impact on the Black electorate should not be overstated. Michael Strawbridge, a political science professor, emphasized that the real danger lies in Black voters feeling disenfranchised and choosing not to vote at all. While Trump's outreach has resonated in specific male-dominated spaces, such as barbershops, Harris's ties to HBCUs provide a powerful platform. The homecoming season is crucial for mobilizing alumni and current students, fostering a sense of community that Harris is leveraging as she gears up for the election.



Trudeau Aides **Briefed U.S. Paper** on India Links Before **Bishnoi Claim**

Two senior aides to Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, including national security advisor Nathalie Drouin, reportedly shared confidential information regarding alleged Indian interference in Canada with a U.S. newspaper. This revelation comes as tensions between Canada and India escalate following Trudeau's allegations about the Indian government's involvement in criminal activities targeting South Asians in Canada.

According to reports from the Canadian publication The Globe and Mail, Drouin and David Morrison, Deputy Minister of Global Affairs, briefed the Washington Post just days before Canadian federal police linked "agents" of the Indian government to the killing of Hardeep Singh Nijjar, a Canadian citizen and pro-Khalistani figure. In June 2023, Nijjar was fatally shot, prompting Trudeau to allege without presenting concrete evidence that Indian agents were involved.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) has claimed that Indian agents have connections with criminal gangs, including the Lawrence Bishnoi gang, asserting their involvement in Nijjar's murder and other criminal activities like extortion and intimidation. However, India has categorically dismissed these allegations as "preposterous" and has noted that the Canadian government has failed to provide any substantiated evidence despite repeated requests.



US Confirms North Korean Troop Deployment to Russia Amid Ukraine Conflict

US Defense Secretary Lloyd Austin confirmed on Wednesday that North Korea has sent troops to Russia, marking the first official acknowledgment of such reports from the US government. This follows warnings from South Korea's intelligence agency, which suggested that Pyongyang deployed these forces to support Russia in its ongoing war against Ukraine.

Austin stated, "We are seeing evidence that there are North Korean troops that have gone to Russia," although he noted that the exact purpose of their deployment remains unclear. He added, "If they're co-belligerents, their intention is to participate in this war on Russia's behalf, that is a very, very serious issue."

The relationship between North Korea and Russia has strengthened since Russia's invasion of Ukraine in 2022, with concerns that North Korean leader Kim Jong Un has been supplying weapons for the conflict. Last week, South Korea's intelligence agency reported that an initial contingent of 1,500 special forces soldiers had been deployed to Vladivostok, Russia, and on Wednesday, they indicated that the total number of troops sent has risen to 3,000.

Despite these developments, North Korea has denied deploying forces to Russia, and Moscow has not provided any confirmation. However, Russian officials have defended their military cooperation with Pyongyang, highlighting the growing ties between the two nations amid international sanctions and diplomatic isolation.

The implications of North Korea's military involvement in the Ukraine conflict could have significant ramifications for global security dynamics, particularly in the context of the ongoing tensions between Russia and Western nations. As the situation evolves, the international community remains watchful of any developments regarding the collaboration between North Korea and Russia.





Market Loses Steam as Indices Break Support Levels, IT Stocks Show Resilience Amid Sell-Off.






2. Bajaj Auto

Increased retail presence in derivatives a matter of concern: Sebi



Ashwani Bhatia, a Whole-time Member of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), expressed concerns on Tuesday regarding the increasing participation of retail investors in the derivatives segment, specifically in futures and options, as well as other high-risk financial products. While he acknowledged the growing interest of retail investors in the securities market as a positive trend, he highlighted the potential dangers associated with this

Bhatia noted that approximately 93 percent of individual traders in the equity futures and options segment have experienced losses, with total aggregate losses surpassing ₹1.8 lakh crore between the fiscal years 2022 and 2024, according to SEBI data. This alarming statistic raises red flags about the financial well-being of retail investors who may not fully understand the complexities and risks associated with trading in derivatives.

The derivatives market can be particularly volatile and challenging for inexperienced investors. While it offers the potential for significant returns, it also exposes participants to considerable risks, especially if they lack adequate knowledge and experience in managing such instruments. Bhatia's warning serves as a crucial reminder for retail investors to approach derivatives with caution and to seek proper education and guidance before engaging in trading activities.

SEBI has been proactive in implementing measures to enhance investor protection and education. However, the influx of retail investors into risky segments underscores the need for ongoing initiatives aimed at fostering financial literacy and awareness. Bhatia emphasized that while enthusiasm for trading is commendable, it is essential for investors to comprehend the underlying risks in-

As the landscape of retail investment continues to evolve, the role of regulatory bodies like SEBI becomes increasingly vital in ensuring that investors are equipped with the necessary tools and knowledge to navigate the market safely. Bhatia's comments highlight the importance of balanced participation in the financial markets, encouraging investors to exercise caution and make informed decisions as they explore various investment avenues.

IMF Keeps India's FY25 GDP **Growth Forecast at 7%**

The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has confirmed its GDP growth forecast for India at 7% for the fiscal year 2025, reflecting a decline from the anticipated 8.2% growth in 2023. This adjustment is primarily attributed to the waning pentup demand from the COVID-19 pandemic as the economy stabilizes and reconnects with its fundamental potential.

In its recent World Economic Outlook report, the IMF noted that the global battle against inflation is largely over, although some countries still face persistent price pressures. Following a peak inflation rate of 9.4% year-on-year in the third quarter of 2022, the IMF projects global headline inflation to decrease to around 3.5% by the end of 2025. This figure is slightly lower than the average inflation rate of 3.6% recorded between 2000 and 2019.

The IMF anticipates global economic growth will remain steady at approxi-



mately 3.2% for both 2024 and 2025. However, many low-income and developing nations have experienced substantial downward revisions in their growth outlooks, often linked to escalating regional conflicts.

For India, the IMF's projection indicates a gradual decline in GDP growth from 8.2% in 2023 to 7% in 2024, and further to 6.5% in 2025. This trend reflects the exhaustion of pandemic-driven demand. The latest Economic Survey supports this outlook,

estimating GDP growth in 2024-25 to fall between 6.5% and 7%.

Pierre-Olivier Gourinchas, IMF Chief Economist, highlighted the global economy's surprising resilience amid the disinflationary period. He noted that the U.S. economy is projected to grow robustly at 2.8% this year, but is expected to revert to its potential growth rate by 2025. Advanced European economies are predicted to see a modest recovery, while emerging markets, particularly in Asia, are projected to maintain stable growth around 4.2%.

Despite encouraging trends in inflation, the IMF warned of increasing downside risks. Escalating regional conflicts, especially in the Middle East, could disrupt commodity markets, while restrictive trade policies and prolonged tight monetary conditions may adversely impact economic growth.

Reliance-Disney merger

CCI approves \$8.5-billion deal



The Competition Commission of India (CCI) officially approved the high-profile merger of Reliance Industries and Walt Disney on October 22, 2024, releasing a detailed 48-page order outlining the conditions tied to the \$8.5 billion deal. This merger is set to consolidate significant media assets, but it comes with regulatory stipulations, including the divestment of seven TV channels.

As part of the approval process, both companies have voluntarily agreed to refrain from bundling television advertisement

slots for their cricketing rights, specifically those associated with the Indian Premier League (IPL), the International Cricket Council (ICC), and the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI), until the current rights agreements expire. This commitment aims to ensure fair competition and transparency in advertising practices.

The order explicitly states, "The parties will not bundle OTT ad slot sales for all three cricketing rights available with them—IPL, ICC, and BCCI for the balance tenure of the existing rights." Additionally, the companies have committed to maintaining reasonable advertisement rates for their TV and streaming platforms concerning ICC and IPL events throughout the duration of the current

In a related development, last month the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (I&B) granted its approval for the transfer of licenses for non-news and current affairs television channels, facilitating the merger's progression. This transfer involves channels held by Viacom 18 Media Pvt Ltd being shifted to Star India Pvt Ltd.


Reliance Industries confirmed the I&B's approval in a regulatory filing, noting, "It is hereby informed that the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting... has granted its approval for the transfer of Licenses relating to Non News & Current Affairs TV channels held by Viacom18 Media in favour of Star India, subject to conditions laid by the Competition Commission of India."

The merger, initially approved by the CCI on August 28, has been hailed as a landmark deal that will establish the largest media empire in India, valued at over ₹70,000 crore. The approval followed careful scrutiny by the antitrust regulator, leading to proposed modifications to the original transaction structure to address regulatory concerns.

Google assures users that their text messages will remain private unless they are reported as spam, reinforcing the platform's commitment to user privacy.

Alerts for Potentially Dangerous Links

In a bid to further protect users, Google is piloting a new alert system for potentially dangerous links sent by unknown senders. Currently being tested in India, Thailand, Malaysia, and Singapore, this feature will block harmful links and notify users about their presence. municate with greater confidence. Plans are in place to expand this

functionality to a global audience later this year.

Sensitive Content Warnings

Additionally, Google is rolling out Sensitive Content Warnings as an optional feature for its messaging platform. This feature blurs explicit media content, giving users the choice to view or bypass it. When users attempt to forward this type of content, they receive a warning about the associated risks. Importantly, all processing occurs on-device, maintaining end-to-end encryption and prioritizing user privacy. For adults over 18, this feature is opt-in, while it will be optout for younger users.

Protection from International Senders

Lastly, Google Messages will soon implement a feature that automatically hides messages from unrecognized international senders. These messages will be redirected to the Spam & Blocked folders. North Atlantic Right Whale Population Sees Modest Increase

The North Atlantic right whale, one of the world's rarest whale species, has experienced a slight population increase, prompting conservationists to call for more robust measures from the federal government and industries to help save these majestic creatures from extinction.

This species, which can weigh up to 150,000 pounds and resides along the East Coast, faced a dramatic decline in numbers

during the 2010s. By the early 2020s, their population had dropped to fewer than 360 individuals due to threats such as global warming, ship collisions, and entanglement in fishing gear. However, recent research indicates that the population rose to an estimated 372 in 2023, a 4% increase from 2020. This news is particularly encouraging after a significant drop of about 25% from 2010 to 2020.

The North Atlantic Right Whale Consortium, a collaborative group of scientists, conservationists, and marine industry experts, reported these findings. Heather Pettis, a research scientist at the New England Aquarium and chair of the consortium, emphasized that while the increase is a positive

sign, much work remains to ensure the species continues to recover. "It's a really vulnerable population. One poor calving year can really impact the total population," she stated, highlighting the need for the whales to be able to calve, breed, and feed without undue stress.

Despite the uptick in numbers, concerns persist. This year alone, five right whale deaths and four lost calves have been documented, marking the highest annual mortality count since 2019. Many of these fatalities are linked to chronic entanglement and vessel strikes, underscoring the urgent need for more effective fishing and shipping regulations.

Conservation groups have faced challenges in implementing protective measures. A coalition recently sued the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to expedite proposed ship speed rules aimed at reducing whale strikes. As these whales migrate annually from calving grounds off Florida and Georgia to feeding areas in New England and Canada, their journey has become increasingly perilous due to warming ocean waters, which have forced them to seek food beyond established protected zones.

The increase in population is hopeful, but without swift action, the future of the North Atlantic right whale remains uncertain.




WhatsApp Developing Custom Sticker Pack Feature for User





Disappointed' Chirag **Shetty Slams Decision To Exclude Badminton**

 $\mathbf{F}^{ ext{ormer}}$ world No. 1 doubles shuttler Chirag Shetty has expressed his disappointment over the exclusion of badminton from the 2026 Commonwealth Games (CWG) curriculum. This decision, announced by the CWG organizers, has drawn criticism as it also omits other popular sports such as hockey, shooting, cricket, and wrestling. Shetty believes that this move will significantly undermine India's chances of securing medals at the upcoming event in Glasgow.

In a recent statement, Shetty emphasized the popularity of badminton, arguing that it is one of the most-watched sports during the Commonwealth Games. "I think it's a very bad decision, to be honest. Badminton has consistently drawn large crowds, and it's evident from the packed venues at the events I've participated in," he said. Shetty, who alongside partner Satwiksairaj Rankireddy secured the men's doubles gold medal at the 2022 Birmingham CWG and also triumphed in the mixed team event at Gold Coast in 2018, highlighted the enthusiasm for badminton among fans.

Reflecting on his experiences at previous editions of the Games, he noted, "It's very difficult to get a seat for any of the rounds. This exclusion is disappointing for the badminton community, especially as we were looking forward to defend-

"I wasn't involved in the decision-making," Gillespie confirmed. He reiterated that his



priority is to concentrate on the players and their preparation, distancing himself from the selection process. "It's not for me to talk about now. I am not a selector. I am a matchday strategist as head coach, and I'm all about the players."



Additionally, Abhishek is set to appear in the upcoming film "King," alongside Shah Rukh Khan and Suhana Khan, where he will take on a more complex role. Directed by Sujoy Ghosh and produced by Siddharth Anand, "King" is expected to begin filming later this year and may be released in 2025.

Megastar Amitabh Bachchan has hinted at Abhishek's involvement in "King," confirming his role as an antagonist, which adds further anticipation for both films. With "I Want To Talk" on the horizon, fans are eagerly awaiting what Abhishek has to offer next.
