Minister Lokesh Invites Tesla to Invest in Anantapur, a **Strategic Hub for EV Sector**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: IT and Electronics Minister, Nara Lokesh, recently visited Tesla's headquarters in Austin, Texas, where he met with Tesla's Chief Financial Officer, VaibhavTaneja, to discuss potential investments in Andhra Pradesh's (AP) electric vehicle (EV) and renewable energy sectors. Minister Lokesh emphasized the state's commitment to progressive policies favorable to industries and highlighted Anantapur as a strategic location for EV manufacturing and battery production.

During their meeting, CFO Vaibhav-Taneja shared Tesla's growth trajectory in the EV and clean energy sectors. He detailed Tesla's recent accomplishments, including an 18.8% growth rate last year and a revenue increase to \$97 billion with a market capitalization of \$832 billion. Taneja highlighted Tesla's success in producing innovations like the Model 3, Powerwall, and solar solutions that are contributing to clean energy storage.

Minister Lokesh expressed Andhra

Pradesh's ambition, under the leadership of Chandrababu Naidu, to achieve 72 gigawatts of renewable energy production by 2029, emphasizing that partnerships with global leaders like Tesla are essential to reaching this goal. He noted that AP's favorable policies have already attracted major automotive companies like Kia and Hero Motors to the state, and he urged Tesla to join this list to further advance AP's renewable energy and EV infrastructure.

Lokesh invited Tesla to participate in projects like so-extended AP's commitment to supporting lar panel installations for smart cities, rural electrifi- sustainable energy solutions and technocation, and innovative battery power storage solutions logical innovation in collaboration with for data centers and IT hubs in AP. Corruption Exposed in APMSIDC **Electrical Department, Contract Employee Accused of Fraud**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Allegations of rampant corruption within the Andhra Pradesh Medical Services and Infrastructure Development Corporation (APMSIDC) Electrical Department have come to light, centering on a contract employee, Phani Kumar, who serves as an Assistant Engineer (AE).

Investigations reveal that Kumar has been managing a civil contractor, reportedly operating un-

der a benami contractor named Vinay. He is accused of submitting fraudulent bills for electrical works throughout the NTR and Krishna districts, particularly at the Government General Hospital in Vijayawada and the Srikakulam Municipal Corporation (SMC).

To mask his fraudulent activities, Kumar has allegedly hired a permanent electrician to oversee these works, excluding other workers to prevent exposure of the corrupt practices. It has been noted that, according to regulations, materials from at least three different brands should be utilized in one project. However, Kumar prefers to use a single brand that provides him with substantial kickbacks.

Contractors working with Kumar claim they





have little recourse to challenge him, as delays in bill payments can occur if they do not comply with his demands. The contractors have reportedly formed a syndicate under Kumar's direction, agreeing to pay commissions and other expenses to ensure their projects are executed smoothly.

Despite being an outsourced employee with a modest salary of ₹35,000, Kumar has amassed significant wealth, acquiring land in Murali Nagar and constructing a new house.

A formal complaint has been lodged against Phani Kumar with the officials of the corruption department, highlighting the need for immediate action to address the growing corruption in the APMSIDC Electrical Department.

YSRCP Leaders Implicated in TDP Office Attack, Claims Panuganti Chaitanya During Interrogation

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Panuganti Chaitanya, a YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) leader and the primary accused (A1) in the recent attack on the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) office, has been remanded for an additional 11 days by the court following his production by the Andhra Pradesh CID police. His custody period concluded on Monday, after which the CID presented him in court.

Chaitanya, who had already spent three days in CID custody, reportedly provided significant information regarding the attack during his interrogation. According to sources, he implicated several YSRCP leaders, including Sajjala Ramakrishna Reddy, ThalashilaRaghuram, Appireddy, and DevineniAvinash, claiming they organized a meeting that led to the assault on the TDP office.

CCTV footage has corroborated Chaitanya's involvement as the main orchestrator of the attack, leading to heightened scrutiny of the actions and communications among those named in his testimony. The CID has expressed intentions to investigate



further based on the information Chaitanya provided.

Chaitanya, a key follower of MLC Appireddy, had evaded capture for nearly five months before surrendering at the Mangalagiri court on October 14. Following the court's decision, he will be transferred to the district jail after undergoing a medical examination.

The developments in this case raise questions about the extent of political tensions in Andhra Pradesh, particularly regarding the allegations of orchestrated violence against opposition party offices. The CID's ongoing investigation is anticipated to bring further revelations regarding the political dynamics at play in the region.

Strict Action Against Wildlife Poaching - DCM PawanKalyan

Toll-Free Number Launched for Conservation Efforts

Mangalagiri: TPN, To strengthen wildlife servation efforts, Deputy Chief Minister and Minister of Forest and Environment, PawanKalyan, has announced harsh penalties for wildlife poaching, killing, and smuggling. During a ceremony held at the Mangalagiri camp office, he released a poster created by the Anti-Poaching Cell of the Forest Department and launched a new toll-free number,



18004255909, for reporting wildlife crimes.

DCM PawanKalyan emphasized the shared responsibility to protect forests and wildlife, echoing Prime Minister Narendra Modi's philosophy of "VasudhaivaKutumbakam" or "the world is one family." He urged citizens to show compassion toward all forms of life, from animals and trees to smaller creatures like ants and cattle, which have an equal right to inhabit the earth.

In alignment with the Wildlife Protection Act of 1972, the Minister reinforced that hunting, killing, and trafficking of wild animals are strictly prohibited, and violators will face severe consequences. He applauded the proactive measures of the state's NDA government, led by Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu, in protecting wildlife and natural re-

sources. The government has been quick to act on recent incidents, such as the arrest of individuals involved in the killing of a leopard at Kaundinya Sanctuary in Chittoor district, who were apprehended within three days.

Citizens are encouraged to report incidents of wildlife poaching, smuggling, or illegal mining via the toll-free number. Prompt action by the Forest Department officials, led by Special Chief Secretary Mr. Anantaramu and PCCF Mr. ChiranjeevChoudhary, aims to uphold wildlife conservation and forest protection across the state.

Forest officials, including Mr. A.K. Naik, Mr. Saravanan, Mr. Rahul Pandey, and Mrs. Shantipriya Pandey, were present at the event, underscoring the department's dedication to safeguarding the region's biodiversity.

ACB Conducts Inspections at APMDC Office Over Alleged Irregularities TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The An-

ti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) conducted inspections at the Andhra Pradesh Mineral Development Corporation (APMDC) office today as part of an ongoing investigation into alleged irregularities believed to have occurred during the previous administration. This action aligns with the coalition government's broader probe into suspected misconduct across various departments under the prior government.

These inspections follow the recent arrest of former Mines Department Director Venkata Reddy, who is implicated in a sand tender irregularities case. Reddy, currently held in remand at Vijayawada Jail, was taken into ACB custody for questioning. During interrogation, he reportedly provided information that led ACB officials to conduct today's searches at the APMDC office.

The ACB is expected to continue its investigation based on findings from the APMDC inspections and further information derived from Reddy's statements.

AP Govt Shuts Down SapNet, Transfers Responsibilities to Higher **Education Board**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a significant move, the Andhra Pradesh government has ordered the shutdown of the Society for Andhra Pradesh Network (SapNet). According to the latest government directive, all assets, staff, and liabilities associated with SapNet will now be managed by the Board of Higher Education.

SapNet was established in 2018 under the previous TDP government to enhance educational services across the state through initiatives like Mana TV, which delivered educational programming to students. However, the current administration has opted to streamline operations by transferring SapNet's responsibilities to the Higher Education Board. Officials stated that this move aims to improve the



efficiency and accessibility of educational services directly through the education board.

The decision reflects the coalition government's approach to consolidating educational resources under a single entity, enhancing direct oversight and service delivery.

AP Power Minister Ravi Kumar Criticizes Jagan Reddy's Handling of **Electricity Tariffs**

TPN, Pradesh: Power Minister Gottipati Ravi Kumar sharply criticized Pulivendula MLA and former Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy for his handling of electricity tariffs, accusing him of imposing a heavy burden on the public during his tenure. Ravi Kumar claimed that Jagan raised electricity charges nine times over five years, leading

to widespread financial strain, particularly on low-income households.

The minister further criticized Jagan for allegedly dismantling the state's power sector, which had been handed over in a stable condition by former Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu. Ravi Kumar argued that Jagan's governance led to an electricity surplus turning into a crisis, citing the financial difficulties faced by AP Genco, strained relations with banks, and disputes over Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) with producers, which he claims tarnished the state's reputation with both national and international financial institu-

Highlighting Jagan's policies, Ravi Kumar questioned decisions that led to the imposition of fuel adjustment charges and permission for the ERC to increase discom tariffs, which he claims further burdened the public. He also cited a financial liability of ₹1200 crore linked to Hinduja Power, which he attributed to poor governance choices made during Jagan's administration.

Additionally, Ravi Kumar accused Jagan of stirring unrest with unfulfilled promises on the Polavaram project and the idea of establishing three capitals. He concluded by stating that the repercussions of the former Chief Minister's decisions continue to impact the state's economy and governance.

AP Govt to Make Classified GOs Public on GOIR Website

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The access to information that was Andhra Pradesh government has announced a significant decision to make previously confidential Government Orders (GOs) from the YCP regime publicly accessible. The General Administration Department has instructed that all classified GOs issued between August 15, 2021, and August 28, 2024, be uploaded to the GOIR (Government Orders Issue Register) website.

General Administration Department Secretary S. Suresh Kumar issued orders directing officials from the IT Electronics Department to update the GOIR website with these GOs, allowing public

The General Administration Department noted that, while most GOs from 2008 onwards have been accessible since the website's launch, those issued between mid-2021 and August 2024 were not publicly available. 



Rachamallu Criticizes CM Chandrababu for Alleged Broken Promises and **Increased Electricity Charges**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: YSR Congress Party (YS-RCP) spokesperson RachamalluSivaprasad Reddy has criticized Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, accusing him of failing to keep promises made to the public. According to Reddy, Naidu has a history of saying one thing before elections and doing another afterward, ultimately increasing financial burdens on the people.

highlighted Reddy that, under Naidu's administration, families

using 200 units of electricity are facing an additional monthly cost of Rs. 400. He argued that Naidu is framing a gas bill reduction of Rs. 200 per month as a "Diwali gift" while placing heavier burdens on households through increased electricity charges. Reddy demanded that Naidu keep his election promises and refrain from further rate hikes.

Reflecting on YSRCP's own record, Reddy noted that during Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy's tenure from 2019 to 2024, the state's electricity-related debt grew at a rate of 7.3%, which he claimed was a more controlled pace compared to the 24% growth under Naidu's previous administration from 2014 to 2019. Reddy



also emphasized that even during challenges like COVID-19 and coal shortages, Jagan did not increase electricity charges and provided 200 units of free electricity to economically disadvantaged families.

Citing past movements, such as the large-scale protest at Bashir Bagh, Reddy indicated that YSRCP is prepared to mobilize against further increases in electricity charges if Naidu's policies continue. He urged the public to recognize what he described as a "people-led uprising" against these policies, asserting that Naidu's current stance contrasts sharply with his pre-election promises.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Political tensions are rising in Andhra Pradesh as former YSR Congress Party (YCP) leaders who left the party voice criticism against former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy. Among them is Balineni Srinivas Reddy, a relative of Jagan who has now joined Janasena. Balineni recently commented on the ongoing property dispute between Jagan and his sister, Y.S. Sharmila, suggesting that their feud is tarnishing the legacy of their father, Y.S. Rajasekhar Reddy. He recommended that both siblings respect their mother, Y.S. Vijayamma's advice to resolve the issue. In response, YCP leader PerniNani dismissed Balineni's remarks, stating that his recent criticisms are politically motivated and align with Jana Sena's agenda.

PerniNani took a swipe at Balineni, questioning his sudden change in tone since joining Jana Sena. "Balineni will say anything for politics.

Tension in Palasa as Ex-Minister Appalaraju Under **House Arrest Amid YCP-TDP Clashes**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Tensions escalated in Palasa, Srikakulam district, after a series of violent incidents between YCP and TDP workers, leading to the house arrest of former minister SidiriAppalaraju. The unrest began on Saturday night when Telugu Desam Party (TDP) Palasamandal president, Delhi Rao, was accused of assaulting a young girl, sparking outrage and subsequent clashes between party supporters.

The situation intensified further when a TDP activist, Korla Vishnu, alleged he was attacked with a knife by YCP worker Allu Ramana on Katy Road, under the jurisdiction of the Palasa-Kashibugga municipality. Vishnu attempted to file a police complaint, and as more TDP activists ar- individuals. rived at the police station, they reportedly assaulted YCP workers, including Ramana and another individual, Manmatha Rao, a known associate of Mohan Rao former minister Appalaraju.

In response to the escalating situation, Appalaraju attempted to visit the police station to demand that cases of attempted murder be registered against those involved in the attacks. However, the police placed him under house arrest to prevent further escalation. Despite being stopped, Appalaraju staged a roadside protest along with his supporters, intensifying the tension. The situation eased only after police assured him that they would take action against the accused

The complaint also raised concerns about STP operations, asserting that faulty billing practices drain INR 3 lakh per month from hospital funds. Allegations also extend to improper

procurement from private suppliers, deviating from established sources like Indian Oil.

Following this complaint, both Pawan Kalyan and Nara Lokesh directed the Commissioner of Medical Health and Family Welfare to form an investigative committee. However, the committee's composition has drawn criticism, as it includes lower-level officials, fueling suspicions that influential figures might shield the superintendent from accountability. The outcome of this investigation will reveal whether the coalition government is committed to addressing corruption within the healthcare system or if past patterns of protecting officials will persist.

Illegal Sale of Firecrackers at VTPS Store Sparks **Concern in Ibrahimpatnam**

TPN, V.V.S. MadhuBabu: Amidst preparations for the Diwali festival, concerns have emerged over the illegal storage and sale of firecrackers at the VTPS store in Ibrahimpatnam, which reportedly lacks the necessary government permits. According to sources, firecrackers are being brought in and sold in bulk, disregarding safety and regulatory guidelines. Authorities, however, seem to have taken minimal action against these large-scale operations, while smaller, unlicensed vendors face frequent fines and legal scrutiny.

The city police commissioner, IPS Rajasekhar, has issued statements emphasizing that strict action will be taken against those who manufacture, store, and sell firecrackers without the appropriate licenses, in line with the Explosive Substances Act and relevant IPC sections. The commissioner further stressed that all vendors must adhere to safety protocols to prevent accidents, especially during the festive season. Despite these warnings, the VTPS store continues its unauthorized operations, sparking concerns about possible corruption and negligence among local officials.

Under Section 19b (1)a of the Explosives Act of 1884, anyone found importing or manufacturing explosives without a license faces up to three years of imprisonment and a ₹5,000 fine. Similarly, unlicensed sale, transport, or use of explosive materials can result in two years' imprisonment and fines under Section 19b(1)b of the same Act. IPC Section 286 also imposes penalties for negligent handling of explosive substances, with additional legal repercussions for unlicensed storage.

With mounting concerns over public safety and rising community pressure, authorities are being urged to investigate and take action against any officials complicit in these unlawful activities. Police have assured that they will monitor all firecracker sales closely, emphasizing the need for stringent adherence to safety and licensing standards during this festive period.

India's Defense Milestone: Tata-Airbus C295 Project Launched

This vision aims to empower India to develop its own manufacturing capabilities, reducing reliance on imports and establishing a robust domestic economy.

The "Make in India" initiative aligns closely with the "Atmanirbhar Bharat" (Self-reliant India) ethos. Initially met with skepticism and ridicule from political opponents, the initiative has proven to be a game-changer. Modi's relentless energy and forward-thinking approach have galvanized an aspirational India, steering the nation towards greater self-sufficiency, particularly in the defense sector.

On October 28, a landmark moment in India's defense history unfolded as Modi and Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez inaugurated the Tata-Airbus C295 project in Vadodara. ny, signaling a significant stride toward self-reliance in defense. Notably, the initiative is set to produce over 18,000 components domestically, ensuring that the entire aircraft manufacturing process is anchored in India.

Under the agreement, India will receive a total of 56 C-295 aircraft for the Indian Air Force. Of these, 16 will be delivered directly from Airbus in Spain, while the remaining 40 will be manufactured locally. The first of these locally produced aircraft is expected to roll out in 2026, with all deliveries slated for completion by 2031, effectively replacing the legacy Avro aircraft used by the Indian Air Force.

The push for domestic defense manufacturing is grounded in the belief that a strong self-reliant security infrastructure is essential for national economic prosperity. The facts speak volumes about the progress made:

- The proportion of defense spending on foreign procurement has decreased from 46% in 2018-19 to 36.7% by late 2022.
- Defense exports skyrocketed from ₹686 crore in 2013-14 to ₹21,083 crore in 2023-24, now extending to over 100 countries.

- India's defense budget has nearly tripled, from ₹2.03 lakh crore in 2013-14 to ₹5.93 lakh crore in 2023-24.

- Significant investments have been made in two major defense industrial corridors in Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh, enhancing the indigenous defense production ecosystem.

With plans for further investment in startups and MSMEs, the Indian defense sector is on a promising path to becoming a self-sustaining powerhouse. The inauguration of the Tata Aircraft Complex for C295 production stands as a testament to how a nation's aspirations can materialize with strong political will and targeted policy initiatives. While challenges remain, future for India's defense manufacturing capabilities.



Reflections on Inclusivity and Communal Identity in Civil Rights Discourse


I recently attended a meeting of an organization dedicated to civil rights, where a speaker raised a concern about the demographic makeup of the attendees. Noting that most participants were Muslims, he urged the organizers to include more Hindus, arguing that the gathering risked appearing solely focused on Muslim issues. He claimed this exclusivity undermined the broader struggle for rights that includes not only Muslims but also Dalits and Hindus facing their own violations.

This speech sparked a deep reflection in me. Why is it considered problematic if a meeting comprises predominantly Muslims? Would the same scrutiny apply if a gathering were overwhelmingly Hindu? When meetings feature 99% Hindus, no one questions the absence of Muslims, Sikhs, or Christians. Yet, a similar composition of Muslims raises eyebrows and is labeled incomplete. If decisions are made by a largely Muslim assembly, will those outcomes also be deemed invalid for lacking Hindu representation?

I must confess that several years ago, I experienced a similar epiphany. Invited to speak in Patna, I found that 99% of the audience was Muslim. This struck me, whereas I had never thought it odd that previous gatheringscomposed almost entirely of Hindus—were deemed perfectly normal. This reflection reveals a subtle but pervasive form of communalism that can even infect those who pride themselves on being logical and secular. Our tendency to accept one demographic's presence as 'normal' while questioning another's reveals underlying biases we might not even recognize.

The meeting focused on civil or human rights. In today's India, whose rights are systematically being eroded? Whose homes are being bulldozed, and whose places of worship are under attack? Which community faces arrests, draconian laws, and continuous vilification from mainstream media? The answers are painfully clear: it is the Muslim community that faces these organized assaults on its rights.

We must confront these uncomfortable truths. It is crucial to acknowledge the specific struggles of Muslims in India, not to diminish the experiences of other marginalized communities but to recognize the urgency of addressing targeted attacks against them. Only by fully understanding and confronting these dynamics can we strive for genuine inclusivity in our advocacy for civil



On October 31, 1984, India experienced a swift political upheaval as Rajiv Gandhi was sworn in as Prime Minister just hours after the assassination of his mother, Indira Gandhi. Unlike previous transitions, which allowed for a mourning period, this change was marked by urgency and chaos. Indira Gandhi's assassination by her own bodyguards, following the controversial Operation Blue Star, set a grim tone for the political landscape.

The circumstances surrounding her assassination were striking: key political figures, including the President and various ministers, were out of the country or engaged elsewhere. This absence created a power vacuum that led to a tumultuous but rapid transfer of authority. The assassination sparked anti-Sikh riots, which were further fueled by misinformation and mob mentality, leading to wide-

spread violence against the Sikh community. As Indira Gandhi's body lay at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, a shadowy power play unfolded. Despite the tragedy, the Congress Party swiftly maneuvered to position Rajiv Gandhi as her successor. There was no constitutional framework for an "acting Prime Minister," yet the party bypassed established norms. The absence of a prominent leader like K. Kamraj, who had facilitated previous transitions, left a leadership gap that was quickly filled by Rajiv's allies and advisors.

Rajiv Gandhi was alerted to the news while traveling in West Bengal and returned to Delhi urgently, with former minister Pranab Mukherjee by his side. Despite the chaos, his ascent was orchestrated with remarkable efficiency. Minister Buta Singh and other loyalists promoted a signature campaign to ensure Rajiv's quick appointment,

bypassing formalities traditionally observed in such transitions. When President Zail Singh returned from Yemen, he faced public hostility as riots erupted in the capital. However, he decided to honor Indira Gandhi's presumed wish for her son to succeed her. Singh's interpretation of the Constitution allowed him to exercise his discretion in selecting the new Prime Minister. The Congress Parliamentary Board, meeting in disarray, formally endorsed Rajiv's selection, albeit after the fact.

Rajiv Gandhi's swearing-in marked a new chapter in Indian politics, shifting the focus from democratic endorsement to swift party control over leadership appointments. Although he won the subsequent general elections in a landslide, this approach set a precedent that would influence the trajectory of Indian politics for decades to come.



Gurpatwant Singh Pannun: A Puppet of Terrorism in the **Khalistani Movement**

Gurpatwant Singh Pannun embodies a bizarre caricature of bravado, often seen in videos where he threatens violence against a nation of 1.4 billion people, armed with the world's fifth-largest economy and fourth-mightiest military. His antics might seem humorous if they weren't orchestrated by the very real threat of Pakistan, a nation notorious for its role in global terrorism.

Pannun represents a separatist movement that has been responsible for some of India's most horrific terrorist acts, including the Hoshiarpur bus massacre and the Air India Kanishka explosion in 1985, which claimed 329 lives. Now, this movement appears to be gaining momentum again, bolstered by funding from the Pakistani ISI and supported by Western nations like the US, Canada, and the UK. Recent violent attacks on Indian embassies and the intimidation of patriotic Sikhs highlight the increasing boldness of Khalistani supporters abroad.

The Western response to these acts has been disheartening. Pannun has publicly threatened violent actions against Indian interests, including a recent warning directed at Air India. Yet, both the US and Canada have remained largely silent, failing to condemn these threats. Canada's historical context is particularly troubling, as it was the site of the most devastating terror attack in its history when Khalistani militants destroyed Air India's Kanishka flight.

Recent incidents, such as the violent assault on the Indian High Commission in Ottawa and attacks in London and San Francisco, reveal a troubling trend of rising Khalistani extremism in the West. While these nations espouse values of free speech and assembly, they ignore the distinction between peaceful protest and acts of intimidation and violence.

Indian External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar has aptly criticized this Western hypocrisy, stating that political convenience should not dictate responses to terrorism. The West seems oblivious to the longterm consequences of harboring radical elements

The dangerous flirtation with extremism, however, threatens to create isolated enclaves of lawlessness in Western nations, a scenario that serves no one's interest.

DMK leader TKS Elangovan stated, "These are all our policies; he is copying us. Whatever he says has already been articulated and is being implemented by us," as reported by the Press Trust of India.

In his inaugural public address, Vijay criticized the DMK's leadership, targeting the party's first family and accusing them of "cheating people in the name of the Dravidian model." He further claimed that "one family is looting the state" through dubious dealings.

The DMK, which has a long history of political rivalries, responded with skepticism about Vijay's party. Elangovan

remarked, "This is the first conference, and let us see; we have encountered many parties before." He emphasized that the DMK has a strong ideological foundation built over 75 years, focusing on fighting for the people's issues, while suggesting that Vijay's TVK is more focused on achieving power quickly, aiming for the 2026 elections just two years after its inception.

Vijay has expressed a commitment to social justice and women's empowerment, drawing inspiration from iconic figures such as Periyar, Kamaraj, and Ambedkar. However, he clarified that while he respects Periyar's contributions, his party will not adopt the stance of "No god," emphasizing that they are "against nobody's faith."

AIADMK spokesperson Kovai Sathyan acknowledged Vijay's entry into politics, congratulating him but cautioning that he has a long journey ahead to establish himself and deliver on his promises. The unfolding political landscape in Tamil Nadu remains dynamic, with established parties scrutinizing the intentions of emerging players like TVK as they prepare for future elections.

"Corruption First": **Eknath Shinde's Take On Opposition Priorities**

Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, following the filing of his nomination today, addressed allegations from the opposition regarding women-centric schemes like "Ladki Behena." In an exclusive interview with NDTV, Shinde dismissed the opposition's claims, asserting that the state government took proactive measures to adhere to the Model Code of Conduct by transferring funds for November in October, before elections were announced.

When questioned about opposition accusations of the initiatives being mere "pre-election stunts," Shinde labeled these claims as fabrications. "They promised quick disbursement of welfare funds under various schemes, but nothing has materialized in Karnata-



ka or Himachal Pradesh. They halted their schemes, claiming they needed to obtain funds from the Centre first," he said. In contrast, he emphasized that his government has successfully implemented programs and made payments, alleging that the opposition's motives are dubious. "Our policy is 'Nation first'; theirs is 'corruption first," he added.

On the topic of the opposition's lack of a Chief Ministerial candidate, Shinde remarked, "We don't have the 'Make me CM' culture." He contrasted this

with the era of Balasaheb Thackeray, stating that prominent leaders would come to meet him, whereas he believes Uddhav Thackeray's current approach is more about soliciting support to become Chief Minister. This comment was a direct jibe at his political rival Uddhav Thackeray, whose government Shinde previously toppled with support from the BJP.

Despite Shinde's aspirations to embody Bal Thackeray's legacy, voter response has been mixed. In the recent Lok Sabha elections, the opposition Maha Vikas Aghadi secured 30 out of 48 seats in Maharashtra, while the ruling alliance managed only 17.

Udhayanidhi Stalin Must Adhere To Government Dress Code: AIADMK



The AIADMK has urged Tamil Nadu's Deputy Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin to comply with the dress code outlined in a government order applicable to state employees. S. According to the Tamil Nadu Government Order (GO), male employees are expected to wear formal shirts with pants or dhotis that reflect Tamil culture, alongside other traditional Indian attire. For female employees, sarees or salwar suits are mandated.

Imbadurai criticized Udhayanidhi Stalin for wearing a T-shirt featuring the DMK flag and the party's rising sun symbol at official events, asserting that such informal attire is inappropriate for government functions. The Deputy Chief Minister's casual dress choices have sparked considerable backlash from opposition parties within Tamil Nadu.







Ishiba's Coalition **Loses Majority in** Japan's Election **Setback**

Japan's political landscape is in turmoil after Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba's ruling coalition faced a significant setback in the recent election, leaving no party with a clear mandate to govern. The Liberal Democratic Party (LDP) and its junior coalition partner Komeito secured only 215 seats in the lower house of parliament, a sharp decline from the previous 279 seats. This loss is attributed to public dissatisfaction over a funding scandal and a rising cost-of-living crisis.

The election results sent the yen to a three-month low, as investors braced for potential weeks of political negotiations and instability. Dhiraj Nim, an economist at Australia & New Zealand Banking Corp, emphasized the discrepancy, stating, "The RBI's forecast exceeds what a margin of error around market forecasts would allow. The overall macroeconomic indicators have not evolved positively in recent months to support the central bank's predictions."

Various sectors are already showing signs of a downturn, with reports indicating declines in car and coffee sales and manufacturing activity. Although factory activity showed a slight uptick this month, it

has generally softened since utive months, and air travel has seen declines in three of the last four months since June.

As the RBI continues to stand firm on its growth estimates, the disparity between its projections and those of economists and market analysts raises questions about the future trajectory of India's economy and the potential implications for monetary policy moving forward..

NTPC Green Energy Set to Raise ₹10,000 **Crore in Upcoming IPO**

Additionally, NTPC Green operates 2,925 MWs through 14 solar projects and 2 wind projects.






