Until My Last Breath, I Will Defend Sanatana Dharma - Pawan Kalyan

Is Rama Only the God of the North? Not Ours?

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: At the Varahi Sabha in Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister and Jana Sena leader Pawan Kalyan delivered a fiery speech, defending the cultural and religious importance of Lord Rama in the country. Kalyan emphasized that Lord Rama is not just the God of the North but is worshipped across the entire country.

In his passionate address, Pawan Kalyan said, "The whole country worships Lord Ram, but if Lord Ram is paraded with shoes, should we just watch? Should we sit in our rooms and cry in silence?" He expressed frustration, referring to the incident where Lord Rama's head was desecrated at Ram Tirtha, and added, "What did we do when Lord Rama's head was severed? We cursed ourselves in fear, afraid to speak out lest we be labeled as fanatics."

He criticized the theory that Lord Rama is only the God of the North, saying, "This idea that Rama is the God of the North is a misconception. Rama is the backbone of our country's culture. Is God not for all of us?" Pawan explained the universality of Sanatana Dharma, stating, "Rama is in the blue cloud, Krishna is in the blue cloud, and Goddess Kali is black. Sanatana Dharma has no color discrimination."

Criticism of Secularist Views and Udayanidhi Stalin's Comments

Pawan Kalyan did not hold back in criticizing certain political leaders and secularists. He condemned those who trivialized the Ayodhya Ram Janmabhoomi Pratishta ceremony, citing how an opposition leader insulted it as a mere 'dance and song' event. "Can any Hindu ques-



tion this? Should we sit quietly as they mock Lord Rama?" he asked, lamenting the derogatory remarks made about the Ramayana.

Pawan Kalyan also addressed recent controversial comments made by Tamil Nadu Deputy I will fight for Dharma," he declared. He also Chief Minister Udayanidhi Stalin, who had referred to Sanatana Dharma as a virus. Speaking in Tamil and English, Pawan Kalyan warned, "Sanatana Dharma is like a virus, some young leaders are talking about eradicating it. But no one can destroy Sanatana Dharma. If anyone tries, they will be wiped out."

Pawan Kalyan, in his speech, declared his un-

wavering commitment to protecting Sanatana Dharma, stating that he is willing to sacrifice his life if necessary. "I will not be afraid, even if I lose my position as Deputy CM.

criticized the courts for seemingly protecting those who attack Sanatana Dharma, expressing disappointment at the lack of action against such individuals.Through his remarks, Pawan Kalyan reinforced his stance as a staunch defender of Sanatana Dharma and made it clear that any threats to this ancient faith would be met with strong resistance.



Tirupati Laddu Controversy Supreme Court to Take **Up Inquiry Today**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The controversy surrounding the use of adulterated ghee in Tirumala's Srivari Laddu has reached the Supreme Court. The hearing on the petitions filed regarding this issue will continue today (October 4). However, due to the bench headed by Justice BR Gavai needing to hear another important case, the Laddu case has been adjourned until 10:30 AM on Friday.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta appealed to the court, stating that an important case hearing was scheduled for today, and it would not be appropriate to delay it for the Laddu case. Considering his request, the Supreme Court decided to prioritize the other case, postponing the Laddu case until tomorrow.

Recently, senior BJP leader Subrahmanyaswamy filed a petition requesting that the investigation into the laddu adulteration case be conducted under the supervision of the Supreme Court. YCP Rajya Sabha member and former TTD chairman YV Subbareddy has also approached the Supreme Court regarding this dispute.

The Supreme Court had previously heard these petitions on September 30 and scheduled the next hearing for October 3. However, due to the importance of today's other case, it was not possible to continue the Laddu case investigation.

Education and IT Minister Nara Lokesh emphasized the need for strict measures during the second meeting of the Cabinet Sub-Committee on the Control of Narcotics, held at the Secretariat. The meeting was chaired by Home Minister Vangalapudi Anita and included key ministers such as Excise Minister Kollu Ravindra, Health Minister Satyakumar Yadav, Tribal Welfare Minister Gummidi Sandhyarani, DGP Dwarka Tirumala Rao, and other senior police officers.

Minister Lokesh stressed the urgency of the issue, warning that, "If we don't take strict action now, we will lose an entire generation." He called for a comprehensive approach, including door-to-door awareness campaigns to educate the public on the tricts and a dedicated narcotics police station in harmful effects of cannabis. Visakha Steel Plant Decision Reversed, Workers Secure Victory

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The workers of Visakha Steel Plant have achieved a significant victory. The management, under pressure from the workers, has agreed to reinstate contract labor. An agreement to this effect was made in the presence of the Labor Commissioner. The management, which had earlier decided to lay off 4,200 contract employees in September, has now reversed its decision and reinstated them.

The united fight of the Visakha steel workers led to this crucial victory. The management's plan to significantly reduce contract workers as part of the privatization process was thwarted. As the workers' protests showed signs of intensifying, the management was forced to reconsider. Negotiations with trade unions were initiated, and the management gave a written commitment in the presence of the Labor Commissioner that no worker would be terminated. This victory has brought joy to the workers, and the trade unions, along with the Visakha Steel Conservation Struggle Committee, have vowed to continue their fight to block privatization and ensure the plant's merger with SAIL.

Initially, despite large-scale protests, the management refused to negotiate with the trade unions. However, a long discussion was held between the steel plant management and contract labor unions on Wednesday, from 12 noon to 7 pm. in the presence of the Labor Commissioner. Ultimately, the management agreed not to terminate any contract workers and to reinstate the labor passes of the 3.700 workers who had already been let go. They also agreed to restore the biometric database in the system and continue using the old format for gate passes.

The management assured that the renewal process for the workers would be completed online within seven days. During the talks, labor leaders emphasized that they would not stand by if any workers were mistreated. Labor Commissioner Mahanthi urged the management to focus on protecting workers' employment and increasing production at the steel plant.

All-party trade union leaders warned the central BJP government that if the Visakha Steel Plant is not merged into SAIL and if its own mines are not allocated, they will intensify their protests. They also declared that if the government's privatization policies are not abandoned, they will showcase their collective strength. Meanwhile, protests at the GVMC Gandhi statue, part of the ongoing state-wide efforts by the Joint Action Committee (JAC) of trade unions to protect the Visakha Steel Plant, continued.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, will convene on October 10 at 11 AM at the Velagapudi Secretariat. Chief Secretary Nirab Kumar Prasad issued an official order on Wednesday, directing Special Chief Secretaries, Principal Secretaries, and Secretaries of all departments to prepare proposals for discussion. These proposals, in the prescribed format, must be submitted to the General Administrati on Department by 4 PM on October 8.

Several significant issues are expected to be discussed during the meeting, including the implementation of the promises made in the election

manifesto. Among the key topics is the progress of the Amaravati capital construction and the Polavaram project, two of the state's most important infrastructural ventures.

Another major item on the agenda is the scheme for distributing free gas cylinders, a key welfare measure, along with the possible approval of the P-4 program. Additionally, the Cabinet is likely to take a decision on abolishing the garbage tax currently imposed in the state.

Other important discussions will include door-to-door tap water installation through the Jal Jeevan Mission and a key decision on the notification of the DSC (District Selection Committee) exams. The AP TET (Teacher Eligibility Test) exams, which began on October 3, will also be reviewed, with CM Chandrababu Naidu previously announcing that the DSC notifications would be released in December following the exams.

The meeting will also touch upon district-wise development issues and new programs to be launched for the welfare of the people. This cabinet session is expected to approve several critical decisions that will shape the immediate future of Andhra Pradesh's governance and development.



Home Minister Anitha Issues Warning Over Eluru Call Money Incident

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Home Minister Vangalapudi Anita has issued a stern warning regarding the recent Eluru call money scandal, stating that the government will not tolerate high interest rates and illegal collections. She emphasized that anyone involved in such activities will face criminal charges and added that special surveillance has been set up across the state to prevent these incidents from occurring.



Anita reiterated the government's commitment to taking the call money and interest business seriously. She made it clear that individuals who harass common people with daily interest schemes would not be spared.

The incident in Eluru came to light when victims of the call money scam reported harassment by a YCP


An Unforgivable Sin As been Done By YCP – Pattabhiram

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Telugu Desam Party National Spokesperson, Kommareddy Pattabhiram, has accused the YCP government of supplying adulterated ghee, mixed with animal fat, to the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) for the preparation of Venkateswara Swamy's laddu prasadam. He stated that the government has not only defiled the TTD but also hurt the sentiments of devotees worldwide.

At a press conference held today at the Telugu Desam Party's central office in Mangalagiri, Pattabhiram revealed several key documents to the media, alleging that the YCP government had awarded a contract worth Rs. 31.98 crores to AR

adulterated.

Pattabhiram strongly condemned the YCP government for committing what he termed as an "unpardonable sin" by using adulterated ghee in the sacred prasadam. He accused the government of awarding the contract for 10 lakh kilograms of pure cow ghee to AR Foods despite the company's inability to meet the supply requirements. He presented further evidence to the public, asserting that the company's production capacity was far less than what was needed for the contract. Pattabhiram explained that the YCP government issued a purchase order to AR Foods Dairy on May 15, 2024, a day before Chandrababu Naidu took charge as Chief Minister. The tender process had been initiated on March 12 and finalized on May 8, with the agreement signed on June 11. He noted that a TTD technical team had inspected AR Foods Company in November 2023 and concluded that the company had only supplied 14,940 kg of ghee for the year 2022-2023, while its monthly production capacity was around 16 tons. Despite this, AR Foods was given a contract to supply



Foods for the supply of ghee, which turned out to be 1,000 tons of ghee in six months, which Pattabhiram described as impossible given the company's limited capacity.

> Pattabhiram also raised concerns over suspicious delays in the transportation of ghee tankers from AR Foods to TTD. He pointed out that one tanker took 8 days to cover a distance of just 500 kilometers from Dindigul to Tirumala, raising questions about the possibility of adulteration during this time. He provided details of several other tankers, which also experienced unusually long travel times, further fueling suspicions. Pattabhiram questioned whether AR Foods was sending the tankers to different locations to fill them with adulterated ghee before delivering them to TTD. Pattabhiram clarified that the government had set up a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to uncover the truth behind the adulterated ghee supplied by AR Foods. He assured that the investigation, conducted under the guidelines of the Supreme Court, would be expedited and that those responsible for this "unpardonable sin" would be punished severely.

YS Sharmila Claims Credit for Vizag Steel Plant's Decision to Retain Contract Workers

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: As the controversy over the privatization of the Visakhapatnam Steel Plant continues in Andhra Pradesh, another major issue recently emerged: the termination of 4,200 contract employees by the plant's management. After the announcement of their dismissal, workers once again took to the streets in protest.

YS Sharmila, the Andhra Pradesh Congress Committee (APCC) chief, expressed solidarity with the workers yesterday and issued an ultimatum to Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu. She warned that if the termination of the contract workers was not reversed, she would launch a protest. In response, the steel plant management today made an unexpected announcement, reversing their decision to dismiss the employees.

Welcoming the decision, YS Sharmila issued a statement, celebrating the reinstatement of the 4,200 contract workers. She credited the Congress party for this victory, claiming that the management's reversal was a result of her firm warning and planned initiation of protests. "This is the victory of the Congress party," Sharmila declared, emphasizing her role in advocating for the workers.

She further assured the workers of the Congress party's continued support, stat-

Btech Ravi Condemns MP Avinash Reddy's Comments

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Pulivendula TDP in-charge BTech Ravi has strongly condemned the comments made by Kadapa MP Avinash Reddy regarding illegal activities in Pulivendula. Avinash had accused the current government of allowing gambling and matka to flourish in the constituency. In response, BTech Ravi defended the government's actions and targeted the YS family, claiming that they have been involved in illegal mining for over 40 years.

Ravi criticized the YS family, accusing them of running illegal mining operations and using dynamite, which he claims destroyed many families. He also stated that the illegal activities Avinash referred to are actually rooted in the YS family's actions, not the current coalition government. Amaravati Hospital Superintendent Defies High Court Orders on Canteen Permissions

TPN, Amaravati: The Superintendent of the Government General Hospital (GGH), Venkateswara Rao, is facing allegations of defying a High Court order regarding the operation of canteens within the hospital premises. It has come to light that he granted permission for canteens to operate in Vellampally and Taneti, seemingly turning a blind eye to the District Collector's directives.

The High Court had previously issued a plea order stipulating that tenders must be called for canteen operations in government hospitals according to established rules. However, Superintendent Rao is accused of ignoring this directive and allowing the canteen operations to proceed without proper tendering.

The matter has led to a petition filed in the High Court, challenging the decision made by Superintendent Rao and accusing him of concealing information from the then District ment resources.

Reports suggest that Executive Officers (EOs) are colluding with brokers, negatively impacting farmers' earnings and experiences at these markets.

Allegations have surfaced that EOs are engaging in various irregularities, including preferential stall allocations and support for those who fail to pay their stall rents. Farmers

Despite the requirement for EOs to be transferred every two years, this protocol has not been followed, leading to allegations of collusion among higher officials to maintain the status quo.

> The lack of action regarding the transfer of EOs raises questions about the government's commitment to supporting farmers. As frustrations mount, stakeholders are keenly awaiting the coalition government's response to the ongoing issues within Rythu Bazars.

During the meeting, Minister Kumar pledged to address the concerns raised by private power generation companies, assuring attendees that their issues would be communicated to Chief Minister Naidu for prompt resolution. He acknowledged that the power sector has been hindered by ill-advised decisions made by the previous government but emphasized the current administration's commitment to strengthening it.

He reiterated that the government is dedicated to creating a business-friendly environment for investors in the power sector, stating that the doors are open 24/7 for power generation companies. Kumar referenced the Chief Minister's ongoing efforts under the "Ease of Doing Business" initiative, first announced during an investor conference in Gujarat. The minister discussed specific issues raised by investors, including Generation Based Incentives (GBI), Late Payment Surcharge (LPS), Tax Pass Through (TPT), and Capacity Utilization Factor (CUF).

Furthermore, Kumar expressed optimism about Andhra Pradesh becoming a

FILM INDUSTRY SLAMS MINISTER KONDA SUREKHA OVER REMARKS LINKING KT RAMA RAO TO NAGA-SAMANTHA DIVORCE

Astorm of controversy erupted after Telangana Minister Konda Surekha made derogatory remarks linking Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) leader KT Rama Rao to the divorce of popular actors Naga Chaitanya and Samantha Ruth Prabhu. The remarks have sparked outrage within the Telugu film industry, with top stars and industry figures expressing their strong disapproval and calling for respect and privacy for individuals in the public eye.

The controversy began when Minister Konda Surekha, during a political exchange, claimed that KT Rama Rao, son of former Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao, had played a role in the couple's divorce. She accused him of tapping the phones of actresses, blackmailing them, and driving them into drug addiction, linking the minister directly to the breakup of Naga Chaitanya and Samantha. The minister's baseless claims were widely condemned as inappropriate, offensive, and aimed at scoring political points.

Chiranjeevi: "We Stand United Against Vicious Verbal Assaults"

Leading the film fraternity's response was Megastar Chiranjeevi, who expressed deep pain over the "disgraceful remarks" in a post on X (formerly Twitter). Chiranjeevi highlighted the industry's frustration with being soft targets for political attacks.

It's disheartening to see baseless statements thrown around carelessly, especially about the film industry," Jr NTR stated, adding that the film fraternity would not sit quietly while baseless allegations were made. He called on political figures to respect boundaries and ensure such reckless behavior does not become normalized.

Allu Arjun: "#FilmIndustry Will Not Tolerate"

In a post tagged with "#FilmIndustryWillNotTolerate," actor Allu Arjun joined the chorus of condemnation. The 'Pushpa' star said the minister's comments were deeply disrespectful and against the values of Telugu culture.

"I strongly condemn the baseless derogatory comments made about film personalities and families. Such irresponsible actions should not be accepted as normal. I urge those involved to act responsibly and respect individual privacy, especially towards women. We must promote respect and dignity in our society," Allu Arjun said in his statement.

Nani: "Disgusting to See Politicians Get

"Today, the claim made by Minister Konda Surekha garu is not only false, it is absolutely ridiculous and unacceptable. Taking advantage and exploiting the personal life decisions of celebrities for the sake of media headlines is shameful," Naga Chaitanya said.

Samantha echoed this sentiment, calling for respect for her personal journey. "My divorce is a personal matter, and I request that you refrain from speculating about it. Our choice to keep things private doesn't invite misrepresentation," she stated in a social media post.

Rakul Preet Singh's Bold Response to Konda Surekha's Comments

In a tweet, Rakul expressed her outrage over being unnecessarily dragged into the controversy. She firmly rejected the baseless rumors, stating, "The Telugu film industry has earned worldwide fame, and I've had a beautiful journey in it. It is disheartening to see such unfounded and malicious gossip being spread. What's more disappointing is that it's coming from a woman in a responsible position."

She continued, "We often choose silence out of respect, but that should not be mistaken for weakness. I have no political affiliations, and I urge people to stop using my name to tarnish my reputation for political gains."

Mahesh Babu Calls statements of Minister as "Cheap and Baseless"

Actor Mahesh Babu has joined the growing list of voices condemning Telangana Minister Konda Surekha's controversial remarks about the film industry, particularly her comments targeting actress Samantha Ruth Prabhu. "It is not okay for someone in such a respectable position to talk utter baseless rubbish in front of the media and think it is acceptable. We all should condemn such practices, which reflect poorly on our society," Nani added.

Nagarjuna Akkineni Condemns False Allegations

Veteran actor Nagarjuna Akkineni, father of Naga Chaitanya, also spoke out, condemning the minister's comments as completely false and irrelevant. He called for respect for individuals' privacy and urged Minister Surekha to withdraw her remarks.

"Don't use the lives of movie stars who stay away from politics to criticize your opponents. As a woman in a responsible position, your comments and accusations against our family are completely irrelevant and false. I request you to withdraw your comments immediately," Nagarjuna said.

Nagarjuna has filed a defamation suit against Telangana Minister Konda Surekha. The suit was filed in the Nampally court, where Nagarjuna requested that criminal action be taken against the minister. Nagarjuna took legal action following the minister's comments, alleging his involvement in the separation of actresses Samantha and Naga Chaitanya. In response to opposition calls for his resignation, he emphasized, "Satyameva Jayate," highlighting his belief that honesty will triumph.

Despite pressures from the BJP and JD(S) for his resignation, Siddaramaiah expressed his conviction that as long as he has the people's support and the blessings of Chamundeshwari, he remains unshaken. "No one can do anything against me," he stated, reinforcing his commitment to serve the state.

Siddaramaiah received unexpected support from JD(S) leader G T Devegowda, who defended him against resignation demands, indicating that the truth behind the allegations should be acknowledged. India Rejects USCIRF Report as Malicious and Biased

India on Thursday strongly dismissed a report from the US Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF), labeling it as "malicious" and accusing the organization of harboring a "political agenda." The USCIRF's report highlighted concerns regarding the deteriorating state of religious freedom in India and recommended that the country be classified as a "Country of Particular Concern."

Rebuke to Lawyer

In a recent session of the Supreme Court, Chief Justice of India (CJI) DY Chandrachud expressed his frustration towards a lawyer who inappropriately questioned the court master about the details of an order he had dictated. The incident occurred on October 3, just weeks before Chandrachud's retirement on November 10.

"How dare you ask the court master what I dictated in the court? Tomorrow you will come to my house and ask my personal secretary what I am doing. Lawyers have lost all sense of decorum," the CJI admonished. His remarks underscored his insistence on maintaining order and respect within the courtroom, especially as he approached the end of his tenure.

Chandrachud, known for his firm stance on court decorum, reiterated his authority during this brief remaining period, cautioning the lawyer not to attempt similar tactics again. "These are my last days in the court," he added, emphasizing the importance of professionalism in legal proceedings.

This confrontation follows another incident earlier in the week where the CJI reprimanded a lawyer for informally responding with "yeah" during a hearing. "This is not a coffee shop! What is this 'yeah, yeah'? I am very allergic to this 'yeah, yeah'. This cannot be allowed," he stated, reinforcing the need for respect in legal discourse.

Additionally, while addressing the high-profile electoral bonds scam case, CJI Chandrachud was critical of a lawyer who raised his voice in court. "Don't shout at me. This is not a Hyde Park corner meeting; you are in court. If you want to move an application, file an application. You have got my decision as Chief Justice; we are not hearing you.

As the region continues to navigate complex political and social issues, understanding voter behavior and preferences will be crucial for all political parties involved. The EC's assessment and subsequent strategies could potentially enhance voter engagement in future elections.

Overall, while the turnout this year fell short of previous levels, the data presents a mixed picture, with signs of increasing female participation that could signal shifts in voter dynamics in Jammu and Kashmir.

Ashok Tanwar Rejoins Congress After BJP Stint

Japan's PM To **Introduce Happiness Index In First Parliamentary Speech**

Japan's newly appointed Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba is set to unveil a new happiness index during his inaugural parliamentary policy speech on Friday, according to local media reports. This index, developed through collaboration between the public and private sectors, aims to complement Ishiba's plans to strengthen the economy and address the nation's declining population.

Ishiba, who assumed office on Tuesday after winning a closely contested leadership vote within the ruling Liberal Democratic Party (LDP), has indicated intentions to call a snap election on October 27. This move aims to solidify his mandate for implementing policies that enhance support for regional governments and low-income households.

While details regarding foreign policy remain uncertain, reports suggest that Ishiba will likely reaffirm his commitment to combating inflation and announce a new monetary stimulus package. Following his election as party leader, the yen experienced a surge due to Ishiba's endorsement of the Bank of Japan's plans to shift away from its ultra-loose monetary policies. However, his subsequent remarks about not supporting further interest rate hikes led to a decline in the currency's value.

Nasrallah And Netanyahu Agreed **To Ceasefire:** Lebanon Minister

Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu reportedly reached an agreement for a ceasefire just hours before Nasrallah was killed in an Israeli airstrike in Beirut, according to Lebanon's Foreign Minister Abdallah Bou Habib. In an interview with PBS, Bou Habib stated that the decision to cease hostilities had received full backing from Lebanon and was communicated to both the United States and France.

Nasrallah was killed on September 27 when Israeli bombs struck his bunker. Although Hezbollah did not officially confirm the cause of death, reports indicated he succumbed to blunt trauma from the blasts. Bou Habib detailed that Nasrallah had agreed to a ceasefire with Netanyahu, a decision that involved consultations with Hezbollah and was communicated to American and French officials.

"The Lebanese House Speaker, Mr. Nabih Berri, consulted with Hezbollah, and we informed the Americans and the French about the agreement. They confirmed that Netanyahu also agreed to the statement issued by both presidents," he explained.

Prior to these developments, the U.S., France, and other allies had prepared a 21-day ceasefire plan, initiated on September 25 following a meeting between President Joe Biden and President Emmanuel Macron during the UN General Assembly in New York. However, Netanyahu rejected the ceasefire agreement the next day, instructing the military to continue its operations.

Iran Claims 'Execution List' of Israeli Leaders, Including Netanyahu

Iran has reportedly circulated an "execution list" that includes high-profile Israeli figures, such as Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Defence Minister Yoav Gallant. The list, shared on the social media platform X, also names commanders from Israel's Army, Navy, and Air Force. This development has raised tensions amid ongoing hostilities between the two nations.

The poster was shared by an account named @Revenge_is_near, although neither the Iranian nor Israeli governments have officially commented on its authenticity. Sources within Iranian military intelligence indicate that senior Israeli leaders, including Netanyahu, could be potential targets.

Both candidates, who have previously exchanged barbs during the campaign, maintained a respectful tone, showcasing their ability to engage in a more dignified discourse.

However, the debate did experience some heated moments, particularly when Vance was questioned about his stance on Donald



Trump and the legitimacy of the 2020 election. Vance, known for his refusal to acknowledge Biden's victory, sidestepped the inquiry about whether he would challenge the outcome of this year's election if Trump were to lose again.

Walz seized on this evasiveness, linking Vance's reluctance to Trump's unfounded claims of voter fraud, which fueled the violent attack on the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021. "He is still saying he (Trump) didn't lose the election," Walz asserted, directly pressing Vance with the question, "Did he (Trump) lose the 2020 election?"



woman have taken these attacks to an alarming level.


The situation mirrors a similar controversy in Andhra Pradesh, where leaders of the YSR Congress Party (YCP) made inappropriate comments about Nara Bhuvaneshwari, the wife of opposition leader Chandrababu Naidu. At the time, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy did not take action against those responsible, a decision that later became a factor in YCP's declining popularity.

Now, Surekha's comments have put Congress in a precarious position. While she has retracted her statements, the damage to both her reputation and the party's image is evident. By dragging in members of the film industry in her critique of political rival KTR, Surekha has overstepped boundaries, especially considering that her remarks targeted another woman, which has intensified the public backlash.

The spotlight is now on Telangana Congress chief and Chief Minister candidate Revanth Reddy, who is under pressure to address the controversy. His response, or lack thereof, will have significant consequences for Congress. If he fails to take decisive action, as YS Jagan did during the Bhuvaneshwari episode, it could be seen as tacit approval of such behavior and may further damage Congress's credibility.

The way Revanth Reddy handles this situation will be crucial in determining whether Congress can recover from the fallout, or if this controversy will accelerate its decline in Telangana's political landscape.

50 Viking Age Burials in Denmark



∧ significant archaeological discov-**A**ery in Denmark has unveiled an extraordinary burial ground containing the remains of around 50 individuals from the Viking Age, dating back to the 900s. This remarkable find occurred during preparatory work for electrical cable installation near the village of Åsum on Funen Island. Over the past six months, archaeologists from Museum Odense have excavated these graves, providing a rare opportunity to study human remains from this pivotal era.

The preservation of skeletal remains from the Viking Age is typically rare in Scandinavia, primarily due to the region's acidic soil, which does not retain bones well. Consequently, the excavation of 50 graves marks a significant breakthrough in understanding Viking culture. Archaeologist Michael Borre Lundø from Museum Odense emphasized the exceptional nature of this discovery, which allows for a variety of scientific analyses to reveal insights into the health, diet, and origins of those buried at the site.

This discovery enhances our understanding of Viking burial customs and underscores the cultural significance of the region during the Viking Age, particularly under the rule of King Gorm "the Old" and Queen Thyra.






