Nagarjuna's Defamation Suit Against Minister Konda Surekha

- Akkineni Nagarjuna files a case in Nampally court
- Nagarjuna claims the minister has damaged the honor of his family

TPN, Hyderabad: Film actor Akkineni Nagarjuna has filed a defamation suit against Telangana Minister Konda Surekha. The suit was filed in the Nampally court, where Nagarjuna requested that criminal action be taken against the minister. Nagarjuna took legal action following the minister's comments, alleging his involvement in the separation of actresses Samantha and Naga Chaitanya. He claimed that Konda Surekha's statements have defamed his family, and he urged the court to initiate criminal proceedings.

Complaint at Banjara Hills Police Station
Several women corporators from the BRS

party lodged a complaint against Minister Konda Surekha at the Banjara Hills Police Station. The complaint was filed following her sensational allegations against KTR and film celebrities. The corporators expressed their disapproval of her comments.

Speaking on the occasion, the women corporators said that Konda Surekha's recent comments have brought embarrassment to members of society. They claimed her allegations were baseless and demanded a public apology from her, as well as a retraction of her statements regarding KTR.

TPN, Hyderabad: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy expressed his anger, questioning "why the farmhouses of KTR, Harish Rao, Sabita Indra Reddy, and KVP Ramachandra Rao are not to be demolished?" He pointed out that all the waste drainage from the rich people is flowing into Usman Sagar and Himayat Sagar. "Should the people of Hyderabad drink that polluted water now?" he asked. Speaking at the launch of family digital cards in Secunderabad Cantonment, Revanth Reddy alleged that protests are being staged in the name of the poor because their farmhouses are at risk of demolition.



create another 30,000 jobs before December. He expressed anger that KTR and Harish are attacking their efforts while they are taking steps to address traffic and flood issues in Hyderabad.

"The people are watching your theatrics with hired supporters," he said, demanding that the BRS distribute Rs. 500 crores, which he claimed were looted from the

state, to the poor residents of the Musi catchment area. He criticized certain leaders who, before coming to power, didn't even own shoes but now have Rs. 1,500 crores in their party's account.

"Have you forgotten the Hydra debate in the Assembly?" he asked, criticizing why the suggestions made during the debate were ignored. Revanth Reddy stated that his government is open to alternatives and has already issued orders to allocate houses to 15,000 people in the Musi catchment area.

Revanth Reddy proposed forming an all-party coalition regarding Hydra and providing advice on how to protect Hyderabad. He stressed that even a small amount of rain causes flooding in the city and that it is everyone's responsibility to safeguard it.

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KTR Questions Congress Minister's 'Secret Meeting' with Adani Group



TPN, Hyderabad: Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president, KT Rama Rao (KTR), has raised concerns about a reported secret meeting between a senior state minister, Congress strategist Sunil Kanugolu, and representatives from the Adani Group at a hotel in Hyderabad. KTR questioned whether this meeting indicated a new alliance between Congress and Adani or if it was part of a strategy to acquire 84 acres of valuable government land in Raidurg.

"Why did Adani meet with the No.

2 in the Telangana Cabinet in the presidential suite of ITC Kohenur this evening? And more importantly, what was Sunil Kanugolu doing in the meeting? Has Adani become friends with Congress, or is it to usurp the 84 acres of precious government land in Rayadurgam? #MysteryDeals," KTR posted on X (formerly Twitter).

Additionally, KTR accused Congress leader Rahul Gandhi of sending bulldozers to demolish the homes of the poor on the Musi riverbed.

Are you a real estate broker or a Chief Minister?



TPN, Telangana: Former Telangana Minister Harish Rao launched a scathing attack on the Congress government and Chief Minister Revanth Reddy. He accused them of a plot to establish a Pharma City on 3-4 thousand acres while planning to sell the remaining 10,000 acres as real estate plots. Harish Rao criticized Revanth's administration, comparing it to a "madman with a stone," and accused the government of seizing fertile agricultural lands from farmers.

In his fiery remarks, Harish Rao questioned Revanth's role, asking, "Are you a real estate broker or a Chief Minister?" He alleged that the Congress government was destroying homes under the guise of beautifying the Musi River and claimed Revanth's policies were more about removing farmers than helping the poor. Harish Rao also reminded Rahul Gandhi of the promises made in the Warangal Declaration and urged him to hold Revanth accountable.

Harish Rao demanded the immediate cancellation of land acquisitions for the Pharma City project and warned that if the government continued to seize farmers' lands, they would not sit idly by. He vowed to take the matter to the Green Tribunal and stand by the farmers in their fight. Furthermore, he suggested that if the Pharma City cannot be built in the outskirts of Hyderabad, the acquired land should be returned to the farmers.

Harish Rao concluded by condemning Revanth's leadership, labeling it as a "fake Indiramma regime," and criticized the Chief Minister for switching parties solely to attain power. He insisted that factories should be built on barren, rocky land, not on fertile agricultural land.

High Court's Decision on MLA Disqualification Case Takes Big Turn

TPN, Hyderabad: In a major development regarding the disqualification of MLAs who defected from the BRS (Bharat Rashtra Samithi) to Congress, the Telangana High Court has issued key directions. This comes after a single bench of the High Court, 20 days ago, ordered that the schedule for the inquiry into the disqualification of these MLAs be released within four weeks. The Assembly Secretary, seeking a stay on this order, approached the Division Bench of the High Court. However, the Division Bench expressed reluctance to issue an interim stay on the earlier order.

In its ruling, the High Court provided clear instructions on the disqualification process. It directed that the disqualification petitions related to MLAs who switched from BRS to Congress should be presented before the



Speaker of the Assembly. The single bench had already ordered the Assembly Secretary to take action and disqualify the defected MLAs.

The BRS had filed petitions seeking the disqualification of the MLAs who crossed over to the Congress party after winning under

the BRS banner. The High Court, in hearing these petitions, directed the Assembly to release the schedule for the inquiry and resolve the matter within the next four weeks. These orders will apply to the three MLAs who were subject to the complaints filed by their BRS counterparts.

The BRS MLAs Padi Kaushik Reddy and KP Vivekananda had filed petitions to disqualify Kadiam Srihari (Station Ghanpur), Danam Nagender (Khairatabad), and Tellam Venkatarao (Bhadrachalam), all of whom defected to the Congress after winning their seats under the BRS ticket. The Assembly Secretary had challenged the single bench's order, but the Division Bench clarified that it cannot grant interim orders against the single judge's ruling, thereby allowing the disqualification process to move forward.



Don't We Demolish KTR, Sabita, KVP Farmhouses?

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He invited KTR and Harish Rao to the Secretariat for a discussion and, under the leadership of Etala Rajender, suggested approaching Prime Minister Narendra Modi for funds. He also called on Union Ministers Bandi Sanjay and Kishan Reddy to join the effort, appealing for Rs. 25,000 crores from the Centre.

Family Digital Cards Initiative

The Chief Minister announced the decision to introduce family digital cards with the aim of making welfare schemes accessible to everyone. He reminded people that, for the past ten years, they had to visit government offices repeatedly to get a ration card. He criticized KCR, claiming that under his rule, people did not receive ration cards. Revanth Reddy emphasized that digital cards are necessary to implement welfare schemes, with the goal of ensuring that every poor person has access to benefits. The family digital card will be useful for accessing ration, Arogyashri, fee reimbursements, and other welfare schemes.

Konda Surekha retracts comments on actors, but sticks to remarks on KTR

TPN, Telangana: Minister Konda Surekha expressed her hurt over BRS Working President KTR's emotional reaction to her comments. She explained that while criticizing him, she accidentally mentioned a family. In a media conference held today in Hanumakonda, Minister Konda Surekha clarified that she holds no personal animosity toward anyone.

Minister Surekha further stated, "I have withdrawn my comments because I never intended to hurt anyone. I made this decision to ensure that the pain I may have caused others is not prolonged. That's why I posted on the 'X' platform (formerly Twitter) in response to this matter. However, when it comes to KTR, there's no question of step-

ping back. He should apologize. But strangely, he expects an apology from me. This is absurd. He is the one at fault, and legal action will be pursued," said Minister Surekha.

Minister Surekha has already issued an apology to Samantha on the 'X' platform. She clarified that the purpose of her comments was to question the belittling attitude of a leader toward women, not to hurt anyone's sentiments. Minister Surekha also acknowledged Samantha's self-reliance and expressed admiration for her. She added that if her comments offended Samantha or her fans, she would withdraw them unconditionally. Minister Surekha urged everyone not to misinterpret her statements in her post on 'X.'



Etala Counters Revanth Reddy Telangana Is Not Your Father's Property!

TPN, Hyderabad: Etala Rajender has responded to Revanth Reddy, asserting that Telangana does not belong to him. He made these remarks while attending a protest organized by the triple-R landless at Indira Park, where he expressed his support for their cause.

Rajender stated that everyone in the state seems to be suffering from some form of distress and that no one claims to be safe. He highlighted that farmers attended the protest with their families and declared full support for their demands.

Criticizing Revanth Reddy, he claimed that the Congress leader behaves as if he is donating money

from his mother-in-law's wealth. He accused Congress leaders of speaking differently when in power compared to when they are not. Rajender emphasized that the government is not a personal asset of anyone and that while he does not oppose giving land for roads and projects, he insisted that proper rates must be offered in exchange.

He questioned how land could be acquired without considering the opinions of local farmers and without listening to their grievances. Rajender further criticized the ruling party leaders for behaving like tyrants, asking how they expect to benefit when they drive everyone into the same pit of despair.

If You Have the Guts, Come to Musi Without Security!

Etela fiercely stated, "Revanth Reddy, if you have the guts, let's both go without security to the areas around the Musi river where houses are being demolished. You pick the date. Shall we go to colonies like Chaitanyapuri? If the people there praise Revanth Reddy, I will retire from politics, publicly apologize, and bow my head to the ground."

He further accused Revanth Reddy and HYDRA Commissioner Ranganath of making false assurances by telling the poor that their houses would not be demolished, while secretly marking areas under the pretext of FTL (Full Tank Level) and buffer zones. "Isn't it because of



you, Revanth Reddy, that people are living in fear every weekend, unsure when bulldozers might come and destroy their homes?" he questioned.

KTR Criticizes Relocation Compensation

The Price for Dreams is Literally Rs 25,000

TPN, Telangana: As Hyderabad authorities continue demolishing homes built in the Musi River basin, the Telangana government announced plans to provide double-bedroom housing to displaced residents. In addition, residents who voluntarily vacate their homes are being offered Rs 25,000 in cash alongside the new accommodation. However, this compensation has sparked outrage, with BRS Working President K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) expressing strong criticism on social media.

In a post on X (formerly Twitter), KTR took aim at the government's relocation plan, stating, "Hearts are stopping – families are being torn apart, yet the government's thirst remains unquenched. The price for dreams is literally Rs 25,000." KTR condemned the approach, emphasizing that families who have worked hard and saved every penny, often borrowing money from banks to build their homes, now face the fear of losing everything to demolition.

He questioned the government's decision to offer Rs 25,000 as compensation for homes built with lifelong savings, saying, "If it were your brother's house or your minister's house, would Rs 25,000 or even Rs 50,000 be enough for demolition? Think about it." He referred to the forced relocation as a "foolish act" by Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's government, highlighting the emotional and financial toll it is taking on affected families.

KTR also cited a tragic incident where a woman and child reportedly lost their lives due to the fear of losing their home, asking how many more lives would be sacrificed for what he described as "greed and scams." His sharp critique reflects the growing discontent surrounding the government's handling of the relocation process, as public pressure mounts for fair compensation and treatment of displaced residents.

TPCC asks film industry not to escalate issue further; says let's stop it here



TPN, Telangana: Film celebrities are angry over Minister Konda Surekha's comments. The TPCC chief said that the minister has already withdrawn her comments. He appealed to movie celebrities to recognize the fact that there are women on both sides.

Telangana PCC Chief Mahesh Kumar Goud responded to Minister Konda Surekha's comments about people from the film industry. He reminded everyone that Surekha's comments were unintentional, and she has since retracted them. He mentioned that the minister not only informed the media about this but also posted it on the 'X' platform. That's why movie stars have requested an end to the topic. Mahesh Kumar Goud stat-

ed that Surekha explained her intention was to question KTR's belittling attitude towards women, and it was not her aim to hurt anyone's sentiments. He urged film celebrities to recognize that there are women on both sides.

"People associated with KTR's party posted on social media against Minister Konda Surekha. The way a sister was garlanded by a brother was trolled. Even movie celebrities must have seen this. Imagine how hurt that woman must have been. Surekha has unconditionally retracted her comments. Henceforth, Congress leaders and ministers must be careful when they speak," said Mahesh Kumar Goud.

Marriott to Establish Global Capability Center (GCC) in Hyderabad

TPN, Hyderabad: In a significant move for the hospitality and tech sectors, IT & Legislative Affairs Minister Sri Dhar Babu announced that Marriott is setting up a Global Capability Center (GCC) in Hyderabad. This marks the first GCC in India dedicated to the hospitality industry, focusing on software, skills development, and infrastructure.



in GCCs and 150,000 engineering graduates entering the workforce annually.

The project follows discussions held in March between Marriott representatives and the Telangana government. During Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao's visit to Marriott's headquarters in the U.S., the company evaluated the city's ecosystem and recognized its infrastructure benefits.

Marriott plans to hire 300 employees by 2025, creating significant opportunities for young tech professionals in the region. Minister Babu emphasized that this center would further bolster Hyderabad's reputation as a global hub for innovation and talent.

High Court Grants Anticipatory Bail to Municipal Commissioner in HYDRA Case

TPN, Hyderabad: Justice Juvvadi Sridevi of the Telangana High Court has granted anticipatory bail to P. Ramakrishna Rao, the municipal commissioner of Nizampet, who faced charges from the Cyberabad police following a complaint filed by HYDRA. The complaint alleged that Rao authorized building permits in the buffer zone of Errakunta Pond in Bachupally.

During the hearing, the judge considered arguments from the Municipal Commissioners Association, which contended that the Telangana government's b-PASS system had overridden the authority of municipal commissioners, transferring the responsibility of approving or denying building permits to the Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority (HMDA). Senior counsel V. Surender Rao

clarified that requests for building permits exceeding 1,000 square yards are automatically referred to the HMDA.

The counsel emphasized that Ramakrishna Rao had no knowledge of whether Maps Infra, the builder involved in the case, had secured the necessary permissions. He pointed out that the municipal commissioner had notified the HMDA regarding the builder's application for permission to construct within the Full Tank Level (FTL) and the pond's buffer zone. After the builder received relief from the High Court, construction activities continued. The judge found no wrongdoing on the part of Rao and granted him anticipatory bail, with the condition that he must remain available for questioning by investigators.

Johnny Master Gets Temporary Relief in Court

- Rangareddy District Court grants interim bail
- Bail granted from the 6th to the 10th of this month
- Court decision made to allow him to receive a national award

TPN, Telangana: Famous choreographer Johnny Master, who is accused of sexually assaulting a young woman who worked as an assistant choreographer for him, received some relief from the Rangareddy District Court. He has been granted interim bail, with the court issuing orders that allow him bail from the 6th to the 10th of this month. This bail was granted so he could attend the ceremony to receive a national award.

Johnny Master had filed a bail petition, stating that he was scheduled to receive a national award in Delhi and requested interim bail for five days to attend the event. The court considered his petition and granted the requested bail.

Even if We Have to Pledge Our Heads, We Will Waive Off Farmers’ Loans!

TPN, Telangana: The Telangana government has proudly announced a prestigious farmer loan waiver, but discontent is brewing among rice farmers, or “rice donors,” who feel left out of the relief efforts. Many of these farmers are demanding the same loan waiver extended to others, and their frustration is aimed squarely at the government. Political momentum is growing, with both the BJP and BRS coming together in support of the farmers’ cause.

The BRS had earlier launched its “Chalo Praja Bhavan” movement, calling for a complete waiver of farmers’ loans, while the BJP recently added to the pressure by organizing the *Farmer’s Assurances Sadhana Diksha*. This initiative received an overwhelming response from farmers, with numerous unions backing the effort, which further intensified pressure on the Congress-led state government.

During a recent event in Gajwel, Siddipet district, Telangana Agriculture Minister Tummalala Nageswara Rao addressed these



concerns. He pledged unwavering support to the rice farmers and boldly stated that the government would “waive off their loans, even if we have to pledge our heads.” Rao assured the farmers that a loan waiver of up to Rs. 2 lakh would be provided to rice

donors as soon as possible.

The minister also promised that after completing the loan waiver process, the government would roll out additional assurances for farmers. He emphasized that the Telangana government is committed to purchasing every grain cultivated by farmers, while cautioning them against being swayed by opposition parties. Rao criticized those who, after allegedly cheating farmers for a decade, are now raising their voices.

In a forward-looking statement, Rao revealed plans to bring the palm oil industry to Telangana, noting that India currently relies heavily on imports. By increasing palm oil cultivation within the state, he expressed confidence that this dependency could be reduced in the future.

Despite the state’s financial challenges, Rao reiterated the government’s commitment to honoring its promises, striving to meet the needs of all farmers while addressing the mounting political and public pressure.

Govt Extorting Money from Real Estate Firms Under ‘RR Tax’: Kishan Reddy

Union Minister and Telangana BJP President G Kishan Reddy has accused the Telangana government of extorting money from businesses and real estate companies under the guise of “RR Tax,” which he labeled as “Rahul Gandhi, Revanth Reddy Tax.” Reddy made these claims during a press conference on Thursday, where he criticized both the BRS and Congress for following similar ideologies and alleged that the government is demolishing the houses of poor people without proper planning.



Reddy compared the financial situation in Telangana to that of Congress-ruled states like Karnataka and Himachal Pradesh, which, according to him, are struggling to fulfill their election promises. He pointed out that the Congress government in Himachal Pradesh is facing such a severe financial crisis that it cannot pay salaries to its MLAs and government employees. He added that Karnataka’s government is also facing corruption allegations, warning that Telangana could face similar issues under its current administration.

The BJP leader further condemned the ongoing demolition of homes along the Musi River, which he attributed to

a beautification project. He argued that the authorities should focus their efforts on demolishing the illegal farmhouses of the wealthy, rather than targeting the homes of the poor. He emphasized that the BJP will stand by the people whose houses are being demolished and accused the government of using these actions to distract the public from other issues.

Reddy also reacted to recent comments made by Telangana Minister Konda Surekha, who had insinuated that BRS leader K T Rama Rao was responsible for the divorce of actors Samantha Ruth Prabhu and Naga Chaitanya. Reddy called the remarks unfortunate and urged the media to boycott leaders who make such statements, stressing the need for responsible discourse in public life.

Revanth Reddy Delaying SC Classification: Manda Krishna Madiga

TPN, Telangana: Manda Krishna Madiga, founder president of MMRPS, has accused Chief Minister Revanth Reddy of delaying the issue of SC classification. He pointed out that although the Chief Minister was one of the first to welcome the Supreme Court’s verdict, it is unclear why he has not taken steps toward implementing it.



Madiga criticized the Chief Minister for acting contrary to the Supreme Court’s ruling on SC classification, which was delivered on August 1. He reminded everyone that the Supreme Court had declared that the state government has the authority to implement SC classification. CM Revanth Reddy had responded quickly when the verdict was announced, but there has been no further progress.

Madiga further mentioned that while the Chief Minister recently released the DSC results and announced that appointment letters will be given on the 9th, he questioned why Revanth Reddy, who showed such urgency in handling the DSC examinations, is now neglecting the SC classification issue. He accused the Chief Minister of going back on

his word given in the legislature.

After the Supreme Court verdict, the states of Punjab and Tamil Nadu have already begun implementing SC classification. The Chief Minister had earlier stated that a committee would be formed in Telangana to address the issue, but no decision has been taken so far. Madiga alleged that the delay is due to administrative pressure on one side and pressure from the Mala community on the other.

To protest the delay, Manda Krishna Madiga announced that demonstrations with black flags will be held across all districts on the 9th of this month.

KTR Has Done Something to KCR... We Will File a Complaint: Minister Konda Surekha

TPN, Telangana: Minister Konda Surekha made intriguing comments, stating that there is a campaign suggesting KTR has done something to KCR out of ambition for the Chief Minister’s position. She noted that after KCR attended the Assembly on budget day, he has not been seen since, raising questions about what is happening at Erravelli Farmhouse. She mentioned that she will file a complaint at the police station regarding KCR’s absence from his Gajwel constituency.

Minister Surekha criticized KTR for taking rash decisions during BRS’s time in power, acting as though he were the Chief Minister. While speaking to the media in Gajwel, she accused KTR of blocking social media to spread misleading articles. She claimed that KTR was responsible for BRS’s defeat in the last Assembly and Lok Sabha elections.

Additionally, Minister Konda Surekha alleged that there was a secret deal between the BJP and BRS in the Siddipet and Gajwel constituencies during the parliamentary elections. She claimed that an agreement was made with the Prime Minister to secure bail for Kavitha, leading to cross-voting from BRS to BJP.

KA Paul Issues 72-Hour Deadline to Konda Surekha Calls for Resignation Over Objectionable Comments

TPN, Telangana: Telangana Minister Konda Surekha’s recent comments on film stars Samantha, Nagarjuna, and Naga Chaitanya, while criticizing BRS leader KTR, have sparked outrage across the state. Surekha’s remarks, deemed inappropriate, have drawn severe backlash, especially from the film industry and political leaders alike. The latest to react strongly is Praja Shanti Party chief KA Paul, who has issued a 72-hour ultimatum for Surekha’s resignation.

KA Paul criticized Surekha’s remarks, stating that if such comments were made in the United States, they would lead to multi-million dollar defamation lawsuits. He described her words as “mad dog” behavior and deemed them illegal, going as far as comparing them to Rahul Gandhi’s controversial comments, but 100 times worse. Paul questioned why law enforcement had not taken action against Surekha and demanded that she personally apologize to Samantha and Nagarjuna at their homes.

Paul expressed concern for the emotional distress that Samantha might be going through due to Surekha’s remarks and emphasized that simply apologizing now would be too little, too late. He also called upon Congress leaders Rahul Gandhi and Revanth Reddy to take immediate action by removing Konda Surekha from her position.

Aside from the Surekha controversy, KA Paul raised questions about Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy’s meeting with Adani, asking why political strategist Sunil Kanugolu was present at the meeting. Paul criticized what he perceives as manipulation of voters, accusing political leaders of encouraging citizens to exchange votes for money.

He urged voters to make decisions with wisdom, warning that if Congress fails to act, the state might witness a return of KCR and KTR to power. Reaffirming his commitment to the poor, backward classes (BCs), and Christian minorities, Paul called for the victory of the Praja Shanti Party, stating that only then would justice prevail for the weaker sections of society.

₹1,600 Crore Seizure in ED Raids on Minister Ponguleti’s Properties

TPN, Telangana: In a recent press conference at Telangana Bhavan, BRS leader Dasoju Sravan made serious allegations following the Enforcement Directorate’s (ED) raids on Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy’s properties. Sravan claimed that the ED conducted extensive searches at multiple locations, including Ponguleti’s residences, offices, and farmhouses, which reportedly lasted for five days. He further alleged that the raids uncovered approximately ₹1,600 crore in cash along with significant amounts of gold.

Sravan expressed concerns over the transparency of these findings and demanded that the ED publicly disclose what was discovered during the raids. He also hinted at political collusion, alleging a conspiracy involving Congress leaders, Ponguleti, and businessman Gautam Adani. Sravan suggested that the meetings were part of an effort to evade ED scrutiny, asserting that despite the national rivalry between Congress and the BJP, a covert alliance exists between the two parties in Telangana.

In addition to the ED allegations, Sravan criticized Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy over the Hydra ordinance, accusing him of bypassing the Greater Hyderabad



Municipal Corporation (GHMC) by establishing new authorities. According to Sravan, this move undermines local governance and weakens democratic accountability in the city’s development.

Sravan also took aim at Minister Konda Surekha, calling for her removal from Rahul Gandhi’s cabinet due to her derogatory remarks about the film industry. He argued that such comments harm the reputation of the industry and demanded stricter accountability from public officials.

In conclusion, Sravan emphasized the need for greater transparency in the findings from the ED raids and called on the government to uphold constitutional principles, especially in matters of local governance and development projects.

Minister Ponnam Prabhakar Accuses BRS-BJP of Alliance

TPN, Telangana: Minister Ponnam Prabhakar made significant remarks in Gajwel, Siddipet district, suggesting a friendly relationship between BRS and BJP. During the oath-taking ceremony of the market committee, he stated that only the Congress party makes decisions beneficial to farmers across the country.

Ponnam emphasized the government’s continuous reviews and support for farmers, asserting that responsibilities extend beyond political positions. He criticized the state’s financial situation, stating that it had transitioned from a surplus of ₹60,000 crores to a debt of ₹7,000 crores. He pointed out that, following recent floods causing over ₹10,000 crores in damage, the central government allocated a mere ₹400 crores in aid.

He further lamented that KCR, who served as Chief Minister for a decade, has not at-



tended assembly sessions or programs in Gajwel. Ponnam accused the BJP-led central government of inadequately funding Telangana and expressed frustration over comments suggesting the Congress government would collapse within a month. He condemned both BJP and BRS for collaborating to implement anti-farmer laws.



Secunderabad Railway Station to Become World-Class with Airport-Style Facilities



TPN, Hyderabad: Secunderabad Railway Station is set to undergo a major transformation, with the redeveloped station expected to offer a world-class, airport-style experience by the end of next year. The revamp, costing Rs 700 crore, will introduce several new features, including baggage screening, a waiting lounge, and a system allowing passengers to step onto the platform only when their train is ready to board, similar to the operations at airports.

The primary goal of the modernization is to decongest the platforms, ensuring that only passengers boarding a specific train can access the platform at the appropriate time. Passengers will pass through security checks and baggage screening before heading to

a waiting lounge, where they will stay until 15 minutes before their train's arrival. An announcement will then be made, allowing passengers to proceed to the platform.

To facilitate this new system, the station will have two entrances—one on Platform No. 1 and another on the Bhoiguda side (Platform No. 10). Both entrances will feature large baggage screening machines, costing Rs 3 crore each, through which all passengers must pass their luggage. This screening process will require travelers to arrive at the station well before their train's departure.

The revamped station will offer a more secure environment, helping to prevent unauthorized individuals, such as beggars and

vagabonds, from entering the premises. In addition, passengers will no longer be able to rush directly to the platforms, as mandatory security checks will be in place.

Secunderabad is one of only three stations under South Central Railway (SCR) being upgraded to world-class standards, alongside Tirupati and Nellore in Andhra Pradesh.

Authorities are taking steps to avoid the issues faced by other stations, such as Bhopal's Rani Kamalapati station, where a similar baggage screening system was installed but not utilized effectively. This ambitious project aims to enhance both the safety and experience of travelers, making Secunderabad Railway Station a modern, world-class hub.

Cockroach Infestation Found at Popular Restaurants in Hyderabad

TPN, Hyderabad: Ongoing scrutiny of restaurants led the food safety department to conduct raids in Hyderabad on Tuesday, October 1. The inspections targeted Silver Bawarchi Restaurant and Bakers, Kakatiya Military Hotel, and Babai Hotel in Patamcheruvu.

Violations Found During Raids at Popular Restaurants:

At Babai Hotel, multiple violations of food safety standards were uncovered. The Food Business Operator (FBO) was unable to present a valid FSSAI license, claiming it was still in the application stage. The inspection revealed a live cockroach infestation in both the kitchen and storeroom. Additionally, food items stored in the refrigerator were found uncovered and improperly labeled, raising significant hygiene concerns. Raw items, such as papad and shahjeera, were discovered past their use-by dates and were immediately discarded.

Inspectors noted open windows without insect-proof screens and doors that were not properly sealed, allowing pests to enter. Furthermore, the restaurant failed to provide Medical Fitness Certificates for food handlers and a Water Analysis Report for the bubbling water used in food preparation. While the food handlers were observed wearing hair caps and aprons, the overall hygiene practices were inadequate.

In a similar inspection at Kakatiya Military Hotel, inspectors found the restaurant operating without the mandatory FSSAI license. Live cockroaches were observed in the kitchen, and the refrigerator was in poor condition, containing expired mustard sauce, poppy seeds, and pepper masala, which were discarded. Ill-fitting doors and stagnant water in drains exacerbated the unsanitary conditions.

At Silver Bawarchi Restaurant and Bakers, inspectors discovered several food safety violations, including cockroach infestations on kitchen storage racks and expired food items such as dark soy sauce and vanilla flavoring agents. The restaurant also lacked medical certificates for food handlers and proper labeling of bakery items, violating food safety regulations.



ED Summons Azharuddin in HCA Money Laundering Case



TPN, Hyderabad: Former Indian cricket captain and ex-president of the Hyderabad Cricket Association (HCA), Mohammed Azharuddin, has been summoned by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in connection with a money laundering investigation involving the HCA. Azharuddin, who is also the current working president of the Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC), has been directed to appear before the ED on Thursday.

The probe revolves around allegations of financial mismanagement during Azharuddin's tenure as HCA president, with accusations of misappropriating funds. The ED is investigating a Rs 20 crore fraud related to the association and had previously questioned other former HCA officials, including ex-cricketers Arshad Ayub and Shivlal Yadav, as well as former minister G. Vinod.

In December last year, Ayub and Yadav were interrogated by the central agency, and the ED carried out searches at nine locations, including the residences of Vinod, Yadav, and Ayub. These actions were part of an investigation under the Prevention

of Money Laundering Act, following three FIRs registered by Hyderabad's Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB). The FIRs cited irregularities in the HCA's finances, including the procurement of equipment for the Rajiv Gandhi Cricket Stadium.

Among the irregularities being investigated are delays in the completion of various projects, which led to escalated costs and alleged losses for the HCA. The ACB's FIRs accuse officials of criminal misappropriation of funds earmarked for items like cricket balls, gym equipment, and fire safety installations.

In October last year, Azharuddin and others faced four criminal cases, with accusations of misappropriating Rs 3.85 crore intended for the purchase of equipment and stadium enhancements. The cases, filed at the Uppal Police Station under the Rachakonda Police Commissionerate, charged Azharuddin and his associates with criminal breach of trust, cheating, forgery, and conspiracy. However, Azharuddin was granted anticipatory bail in these cases by a city court.

Azharuddin has consistently denied the allegations, calling them false and politically motivated. His term as HCA president, which began in 2019, ended in February 2023 when the Supreme Court appointed a one-member committee to oversee the association's affairs and conduct elections. Infighting during his tenure led to a legal battle that reached the Supreme Court, ultimately disqualifying Azharuddin from contesting the HCA elections due to a conflict of interest. The court ruled that his dual role as president of the Deccan Blues Cricket Club and HCA president was untenable.

Flight Fares from Hyderabad Airport Spike Due to Iran-Israel Conflict

TPN, Hyderabad: Amid escalating tensions in the Middle East due to the ongoing conflict between Iran and Israel, flight fares from Hyderabad Airport to the United States and Canada via London have surged significantly. Fares for flights from Hyderabad to various US cities through Heathrow have increased by approximately 50 percent.

Currently, flight fares from Hyderabad to the US are exceeding Rs 1.5 lakh, with some flights crossing the Rs 1 lakh mark. This spike in prices is attributed to airlines avoiding routes through Middle Eastern countries, which typically have lower fares ranging from Rs 50,000 to Rs 1 lakh. Flights from Hyderabad to the US and Canada generally transit through major cities like Dubai, Doha, Abu Dhabi, or London. In contrast, fares for flights to the US via the Middle East remain stable at Rs 75,000–80,000.

In related developments, Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian stated that while Iran does not seek war, the country will respond if provoked by Israel. His comments came after a meeting with Qatari Emir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani during a two-day visit aimed at strengthening bilateral ties and regional cooperation. Meanwhile, Israel launched an airstrike targeting a Health Authority Center affiliated with Hezbollah in central Beirut, causing significant damage and prompting emergency rescue operations.

Rs. 25 Thousand Incentive for Moosi Victims

- Moosi residents unwilling to vacate their houses despite being allotted double-bedroom houses
- So far, 40 percent of people have vacated their homes and moved to the new double-bedroom houses
- Revenue officials will meet with every displaced family to understand their concerns



TPN, Hyderabad: Moosi victims are being allocated two-bedroom houses, but some are still reluctant to move. Many of the residents of Moosi earn their livelihood through small jobs, and because of this, even though the government is offering double-bedroom houses, many are hesitant to relocate to remote areas. To encourage them, the government has decided to provide an incentive of Rs. 25 thousand to the affected families who agree to move to the areas where double-bedroom houses are allocated. The revenue authorities will provide this amount at the time the families vacate their current homes. The government hopes this money will help the families during their first week after relocation.

However, the residents have raised concerns with the authorities, citing issues such as the lack of work opportunities in the areas where the double-bedroom houses are located, as well as the unsuitability of these areas for small traders selling fruits and vegetables. They are requesting that the houses be allocated within two to three kilometers of their current residences. As of now, those living in Himayatnagar, Amberpet, Rajendranagar, and Gandipet mandals are being allotted double-bedroom houses in areas such as Pilligudeselu, Jiyaguda, and Narsingi.

So far, only 40 percent of the residents have vacated their homes. In response, the authorities have decided to understand the issues faced by the remaining 60 percent of families who have yet to move. Revenue officials plan to meet with each family today and tomorrow to understand their problems and report them to higher authorities in order to find solutions.

Group 4 Exam Results Protest at Gandhi Bhavan

TPN, Hyderabad: A large group of candidates awaiting the final results of the Group 4 examination staged a protest at Gandhi Bhavan in Telangana, expressing frustration over delays in job allocations. Despite completing the certificate verification process two months ago, the candidates claimed that no further steps have been taken, accusing the BRS government of negligence.

The protesters pointed out that it has been 460 days since the exam was conducted, and yet their job allocations remain pending. They questioned how the Telangana Public Ser-

vice Commission (TGPSC) managed to complete the DSC recruitment in just 56 days, while the Group 4 process has been dragged on for over a year.

Chief Minister Revanth Reddy recently assured the public that the government is speeding up the process. However, the candidates demanded concrete action, calling for the announcement of the final results by the Dasara festival. A large number of protestors were detained by the police during the demonstration, but their demands for a timely resolution remain strong.





FILM INDUSTRY SLAMS MINISTER KONDA SUREKHA OVER REMARKS LINKING KT RAMA RAO TO NAGA-SAMANTHA DIVORCE

A storm of controversy erupted after Telangana Minister Konda Surekha made derogatory remarks linking Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) leader KT Rama Rao to the divorce of popular actors Naga Chaitanya and Samantha Ruth Prabhu. The remarks have sparked outrage within the Telugu film industry, with top stars and industry figures expressing their strong disapproval and calling for respect and privacy for individuals in the public eye.

The controversy began when Minister Konda Surekha, during a political exchange, claimed that KT Rama Rao, son of former Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao, had played a role in the couple's divorce. She accused him of tapping the phones of actresses, blackmailing them, and driving them into drug addiction, linking the minister directly to the breakup of Naga Chaitanya and Samantha. The minister's baseless claims were widely condemned as inappropriate, offensive, and aimed at scoring political points.

Chiranjeevi: "We Stand United Against Vicious Verbal Assaults"

Leading the film fraternity's response was Megastar Chiranjeevi, who expressed deep pain over the "disgraceful remarks" in a post on X (formerly Twitter). Chiranjeevi highlighted the industry's frustration with being soft targets for political attacks.

"It is a shame that celebrities and members of the film fraternity become easy targets to gain attention. We, as the Film Industry, stand united in opposing such vicious verbal assaults," Chiranjeevi wrote. He stressed that dragging unconnected people, especially women, into political disputes was unacceptable. "We choose our leaders to improve society, not contaminate it with such distasteful discourse. I trust the concerned individuals will withdraw these malicious remarks immediately," he concluded.

Mahesh Babu Calls statements of Minister as "Cheap and Baseless"

Actor Mahesh Babu has joined the growing list of voices condemning Telangana Minister Konda Surekha's controversial remarks about the film industry, particularly her comments targeting actress Samantha Ruth Prabhu. In a tweet, Mahesh Babu expressed his deep disappointment and hurt over the incident, stating that as a father to a daughter, a husband to a wife, and a son to a mother, he found the minister's comments deeply painful and unacceptable.

The actor emphasized that while freedom of speech is important, it should not come at the cost of hurting others' sentiments. He condemned Surekha's statements as cheap and baseless, and firmly stated that such behavior is not acceptable in public discourse.

Mahesh Babu also made an appeal to politicians and the public to avoid targeting the film industry, reminding everyone that the industry should not be taken lightly or disrespected. He urged that the women in the film industry, and across the country, deserve respect and consideration, calling for a more respectful and thoughtful approach in such discussions.

Jr NTR: "Public Figures Must Maintain Dignity"

Another major voice to condemn the minister's remarks was actor Jr NTR, who said dragging personal lives into politics was a "new low." The 'RRR' star emphasized the responsibility that comes with holding a public office.

"Public figures, especially those in responsible positions, must maintain dignity and respect for privacy. It's disheartening to see baseless statements thrown around carelessly, especially about the film industry," Jr NTR stated, adding that the film fraternity would not sit quietly while baseless allegations were made. He called on political figures to respect boundaries and ensure such reckless behavior does not become normalized.

Allu Arjun: "#FilmIndustry Will Not Tolerate"

In a post tagged with "#FilmIndustryWillNotTolerate," actor Allu Arjun joined the chorus of condemnation. The 'Pushpa' star said the minister's comments were deeply disrespectful and against the values of Telugu culture.

"I strongly condemn the baseless derogatory comments made about film personalities and families. Such irresponsible actions should not be accepted as normal. I urge those involved to act responsibly and respect individual privacy, especially towards women. We must promote respect and dignity in our society," Allu Arjun said in his statement.

Nani: "Disgusting to See Politicians Get Away With Nonsense"

Actor Nani also expressed his anger, calling it "disgusting" that politicians felt they could get away with making baseless remarks. In a post on X, Nani criticized the irresponsible nature of the minister's comments, stating that it reflected poorly on those in leadership positions.

"It is not okay for someone in such a respectable position to talk utter baseless rubbish in front of the media and think it is acceptable. We all should condemn such practices, which reflect poorly on our society," Nani added.

Nagarjuna Akkineni Condemns False Allegations

Veteran actor Nagarjuna Akkineni, father of Naga Chaitanya, also spoke out, condemning the minister's comments as completely false and irrelevant. He called for respect for individuals' privacy and urged Minister Surekha to withdraw her remarks.

"Don't use the lives of movie stars who stay away from politics to criticize your opponents. As a woman in a responsible position, your comments and accusations against our family are completely irrelevant and false. I request you to withdraw your comments immediately," Nagarjuna said.

Nagarjuna has filed a defamation suit against Telangana Minister Konda Surekha. The suit was filed in the Nampally court, where Nagarjuna requested that criminal action be taken against the minister. Nagarjuna took legal action following the minister's comments, alleging his involvement in the separation of actresses Samantha and Naga Chaitanya. He claimed that Konda Surekha's statements have defamed his family, and he urged the court to initiate criminal proceedings.

Samantha and Naga Chaitanya Address the Issue

Both Naga Chaitanya and Samantha Ruth Prabhu, the actors at the center of the controversy, responded to the allegations with dignity and clarity. Naga Chaitanya addressed the personal pain involved in a divorce, explaining that it had been a mutual decision based on different life goals.

"Today, the claim made by Minister Konda Surekha garu is not only false, it is absolutely ridiculous and unacceptable. Taking advantage and exploiting the personal life decisions of celebrities for the sake of media headlines is shameful," Naga Chaitanya said.

Samantha echoed this sentiment, calling for respect for her personal journey. "My divorce is a personal matter, and I request that you refrain from speculating about it. Our choice to keep things private doesn't invite misrepresentation," she stated in a social media post.

Rakul Preet Singh's Bold Response to Konda Surekha's Comments

In a tweet, Rakul expressed her outrage over being unnecessarily dragged into the controversy. She firmly rejected the baseless rumors, stating, "The Telugu film industry has earned worldwide fame, and I've had a beautiful journey in it. It is disheartening to see such unfounded and malicious gossip being spread. What's more disappointing is that it's coming from a woman in a responsible position."

She continued, "We often choose silence out of respect, but that should not be mistaken for weakness. I have no political affiliations, and I urge people to stop using my name to tarnish my reputation for political gains."

Rakul further urged people to refrain from dragging creative artists into political agendas. "Stop creating fabricated stories and linking artists' names just to make headlines," she wrote on X (formerly Twitter), making her stance clear against the irresponsible use of her name in political narratives.

Minister Issues Clarification, Faces Defamation Notice



Amid mounting backlash, Minister Konda Surekha issued a clarification, stating that her remarks were aimed at questioning KT Rama Rao's treatment of women, not at hurting Samantha. Despite this, KT Rama Rao has sent a defamation notice to the minister, accusing the Congress party of indulging in "disgusting and nauseating politics."

The massive response from the film fraternity has prompted Telangana Congress chief Mahesh Goud to intervene. Goud urged film personalities to put an end to the controversy, emphasizing that the minister had apologized and withdrawn her comments.

This row has highlighted the growing frustration within the film industry over being dragged into political disputes and underscores the demand for greater respect for privacy and dignity in public discourse.

Congress Represents Nepotism and Casteism: PM Modi

In a last-minute push against the Congress party just hours before campaigning concluded for the Haryana Assembly elections, Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched a series of sharp critiques. He asserted that Congress embodies corruption, casteism, communalism, and nepotism, urging voters to reject its "divisive and negative" politics.

In his tweets on X, Prime Minister Modi expressed confidence in the BJP's prospects for a third consecutive term, citing his recent travels across Haryana and the enthusiastic response from the public. He contrasted the BJP's governance in Haryana since 2014, which he claimed has focused on prosperity and welfare for all, with the failures of Congress administrations in neighboring states like Himachal Pradesh and Karnataka.

"The people of Haryana understand that Congress guarantees corruption and selfish politics, embodied in the 'bapubete ki rajneeti' (father-son politics)," he wrote in Hindi. He argued that the infighting within Congress, even while in opposition, indicates that the party is incapable of providing a stable government for the state.

Modi also indirectly targeted Rahul



Gandhi, the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, referencing recent comments made by Gandhi about reservation policies during his trip to the United States. Modi asserted that the Congress could never strengthen India and called on Haryana voters to support the BJP in order to contribute to the nation's growth.

In a rally held earlier in Nuh, Rahul Gandhi countered Modi's assertions, framing the electoral battle as one between love and hatred. He emphasized

the importance of rejecting hate and highlighted that India should be a nation rooted in love and compassion. Gandhi accused the BJP and the RSS of undermining the Constitution, arguing that without it, the poor would suffer the most.

With polling set to take place in all 90 Assembly constituencies in Haryana on Saturday, the political landscape remains charged as both parties make their final appeals to voters before counting begins on October 8.



CJI DY Chandrachud Issues Stern Rebuke to Lawyer

In a recent session of the Supreme Court, Chief Justice of India (CJI) DY Chandrachud expressed his frustration towards a lawyer who inappropriately questioned the court master about the details of an order he had dictated. The incident occurred on October 3, just weeks before Chandrachud's retirement on November 10.

"How dare you ask the court master what I dictated in the court? Tomorrow you will come to my house and ask my personal secretary what I am doing. Lawyers have lost all sense of decorum," the CJI admonished. His remarks underscored his insistence on maintaining order and respect within the courtroom, especially as he approached the end of his tenure.

Chandrachud, known for his firm stance on court decorum, reiterated his authority during this brief remaining period, cautioning the lawyer not to attempt similar tactics again. "These are my last days in the court," he added, emphasizing the importance of professionalism in legal proceedings.

This confrontation follows another incident earlier in the week where the CJI reprimanded a lawyer for informally responding with "yeah" during a hearing. "This is not a coffee shop! What is this 'yeah, yeah'? I am very allergic to this 'yeah, yeah'. This cannot be allowed," he stated, reinforcing the need for respect in legal discourse.

Additionally, while addressing the high-profile electoral bonds scam case, CJI Chandrachud was critical of a lawyer who raised his voice in court. "Don't shout at me. This is not a Hyde Park corner meeting; you are in court. If you want to move an application, file an application. You have got my decision as Chief Justice; we are not hearing you.

J&K turnout at 63.88%, lower than 2014 elections



The recently concluded three phases of the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly elections saw an overall voter turnout of 63.88%, a decline compared to the turnout during the last Assembly elections in 2014. The Election Commission (EC) released this data on Thursday, highlighting the participation rates among different demographics.

In terms of gender, male voters recorded a turnout of 64.68%, while female voters had a slightly lower turnout of 63.04%. Interestingly, in the third phase of the elections held on Tuesday, the turnout was notably higher at 69.69%. Female participation in this phase outperformed male participation, with 70.02% of women voting compared to 69.37% of men.

The overall turnout of 63.88% this year contrasts with the 65.52% recorded in the last Assembly elections, which included postal ballots. This decrease in voter participation has raised questions about voter engagement and the factors contributing to the lower turnout.

The EC is likely to analyze the reasons behind this decline to improve future electoral processes. Factors such as political dynamics, voter sentiment, and the security situation in the region may have played a role in influencing the turnout figures.

Despite the lower overall turnout, the data from the third phase indicates a strong participation rate among women, suggesting that efforts to encourage female voters may be yielding positive results.

As the region continues to navigate complex political and social issues, understanding voter behavior and preferences will be crucial for all political parties involved. The EC's assessment and subsequent strategies could potentially enhance voter engagement in future elections.

Overall, while the turnout this year fell short of previous levels, the data presents a mixed picture, with signs of increasing female participation that could signal shifts in voter dynamics in Jammu and Kashmir.



Ashok Tanwar Rejoins Congress After BJP Stint

Former Lok Sabha MP Ashok Tanwar made headlines once again as he rejoined the Congress party during a rally led by Rahul Gandhi in Mahendragarh, Haryana, on Thursday. This move marks Tanwar's return to the Congress fold after a series of political shifts over the past few years.

Tanwar, who previously served as the Haryana Congress chief from 2014 to 2019, left the party amid internal disagreements and subsequently ventured into other political realms. He joined the Trinamool Congress in 2021, before shifting allegiance to the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) the following year. However, his tenure with AAP was short-lived as he departed before the Lok Sabha elections, primarily due to his opposition to AAP leader Arvind Kejriwal's alliance with the Congress.

After a challenging election campaign where he represented the BJP but did not succeed, Tanwar's decision to return to Congress is seen as an effort to reconnect with his political roots. His re-entry into the party comes at a crucial time when Congress is looking to strengthen its position in Haryana, a state where it has faced significant challenges in recent elections.



I have faith in judiciary Truth will prevail,says Karnataka CM

Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, facing scrutiny over the MUDA (Mysuru Urban Development Authority) 'scam,' asserted his confidence in the truth prevailing during the inaugural ceremony of the ten-day Dasara celebrations at the Chamundeshwari temple in Mysuru. In response to opposition calls for his resignation, he emphasized, "Satyameva Jayate," highlighting his belief that honesty will triumph.

Despite pressures from the BJP and JD(S) for his resignation, Siddaramaiah expressed his conviction that as long as he has the people's support and the blessings of Chamundeshwari, he remains unshaken. "No one can do anything against me," he stated, reinforcing his commitment to serve the state.

Siddaramaiah received unexpected support from JD(S) leader G T Devegowda, who defended him against resignation demands, indicating that the truth behind the allegations should be acknowledged. The Chief Minister, reflecting on his political journey, reminded the audience of his successful electoral history, having won multiple elections from the Chamundeshwari constituency.

In his address, Siddaramaiah reiterated that he had done nothing wrong and highlighted his long-standing political career, which spans over 40 years. He expressed gratitude to G T Devegowda for his supportive remarks, stating, "His statement that truth will triumph has instilled more strength in me."

India Rejects USCIRF Report as Malicious and Biased

India on Thursday strongly dismissed a report from the US Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF), labeling it as "malicious" and accusing the organization of harboring a "political agenda." The USCIRF's report highlighted concerns regarding the deteriorating state of religious freedom in India and recommended that the country be classified as a "Country of Particular Concern."

Indian officials expressed dismay at the commission's conclusions, arguing that the report fails to accurately reflect the reality of religious freedom in the country. They emphasized that India is a diverse nation that respects and upholds the rights of all its citizens, irrespective of their religious beliefs.

The USCIRF has repeatedly criticized India in its annual reports, alleging that the government has implemented policies that adversely affect minority communities. However, the Indian government contends that the commission's assessments are based on selective information and lack an understanding of the country's complexities.

In response to the USCIRF's latest recommendation, a spokesperson for the Indian Ministry of External Affairs reiterated the government's stance, stating that such reports are not only biased but also politically motivated. They asserted that the findings do not take into account the efforts made by the Indian government to promote religious harmony and protect the rights of all citizens.

The ongoing debate over religious freedom in India has attracted international attention, with various organizations weighing in on the issue.



Japan's PM To Introduce Happiness Index In First Parliamentary Speech

Japan's newly appointed Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba is set to unveil a new happiness index during his inaugural parliamentary policy speech on Friday, according to local media reports. This index, developed through collaboration between the public and private sectors, aims to complement Ishiba's plans to strengthen the economy and address the nation's declining population.

Ishiba, who assumed office on Tuesday after winning a closely contested leadership vote within the ruling Liberal Democratic Party (LDP), has indicated intentions to call a snap election on October 27. This move aims to solidify his mandate for implementing policies that enhance support for regional governments and low-income households.

While details regarding foreign policy remain uncertain, reports suggest that Ishiba will likely reaffirm his commitment to combating inflation and announce a new monetary stimulus package. Following his election as party leader, the yen experienced a surge due to Ishiba's endorsement of the Bank of Japan's plans to shift away from its ultra-loose monetary policies. However, his subsequent remarks about not supporting further interest rate hikes led to a decline in the currency's value.

In addition to these economic strategies, Ishiba plans to increase Japan's average minimum wage to 1,500 yen (\$10.22) by 2030, up from the current rate of 1,055 yen. These initiatives are part of a broader vision to enhance the public's quality of life and boost per-capita GDP in Japan, the world's fourth-largest economy.

Ishiba is expected to address the challenges posed by the country's rapidly aging population, which he has described as a "silent crisis" impacting the nation's core. Furthermore, he plans to propose the establishment of a new disaster management ministry to better prepare for earthquakes and floods, as well as emphasize the importance of nuclear energy.

The topic of nuclear power remains controversial in Japan, with support from the business sector but public apprehension following the 2011 Fukushima disaster. Analysts suggest that Ishiba's speech will reflect a strong awareness of the impending general election, with an emphasis on consolidating power and securing electoral support.

Jaishankar and Blinken Discuss Strengthening US-India Ties in Washington

External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar met with US Secretary of State Antony Blinken in Washington, D.C., to discuss collaboration on regional and global challenges. This marked Jaishankar's first visit to the US capital since the third Modi government took office. The meeting took place at the US State Department's Foggy Bottom headquarters.

Following their discussions, Blinken emphasized the ongoing partnership between the US and India. He stated, "Together, the US and India are working to address regional and global challenges," highlighting their cooperation on issues such as the climate crisis and promoting regional security and prosperity.

Jaishankar expressed his pleasure in holding talks with Blinken, noting the continuation of discussions from the recent bilateral meeting between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Joe Biden, as well as the QUAD meetings involving leaders from Australia and Japan. He mentioned that their conversation included deepening bilateral cooperation, the situation in West Asia, developments in the Indian subcontinent, the Indo-Pacific, and the ongoing conflict in Ukraine.

US State Department spokesperson Matthew Miller reiterated the commitment from both countries to en-



hance bilateral ties. He noted that Jaishankar and Blinken discussed advancing cooperation on critical and emerging technologies, alongside plans for expanding collaboration on clean energy initiatives to tackle the global climate crisis.

Welcoming Jaishankar, Blinken highlighted the unprecedented warmth and ambition in the US-India relationship, underscoring the significance of their partnership across various sectors, including strategic technology, space, and semiconductors. He acknowledged India's critical role on the global stage in promoting peace and stability.

Jaishankar's visit also included participation in a discussion at the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, where he reflected on the fruitful recent meetings between the leaders of both countries. He emphasized that the meetings provided an opportunity to evaluate progress in multiple areas and address pressing global issues.

Overall, the talks between Jaishankar and Blinken reflect the strengthening ties between the US and India, with both nations committed to working together for the benefit of their people and the broader international community.

Iran Claims 'Execution List' of Israeli Leaders, Including Netanyahu

Iran has reportedly circulated an "execution list" that includes high-profile Israeli figures, such as Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Defence Minister Yoav Gallant. The list, shared on the social media platform X, also names commanders from Israel's Army, Navy, and Air Force. This development has raised tensions amid ongoing hostilities between the two nations.

The poster was shared by an account named @Revenge_is_near, although neither the Iranian nor Israeli governments have officially commented on its authenticity. Sources within Iranian military intelligence indicate that senior Israeli leaders, including Netanyahu, could be potential targets.

The list features other notable military figures, such as Chief of General Staff Herzi Halevi, his deputy Amir Baram, and the heads of Israel's Northern, Southern, and Central Commands—Major Generals



Ori Gordin, Yehuda Fox, and Eliezer Toledani. Additionally, Aharon Haliva, the chief of military intelligence, is named.

If the list proves to be genuine, it may reflect Iran's intent to respond aggressively to perceived threats from Israel, particularly following

reports that Israel aims to exploit recent setbacks faced by Hezbollah, the Iran-backed militant group. The situation has escalated since Israel reportedly targeted the leadership structure of Hezbollah, raising concerns that it may consider actions against Iran's Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei.

The heightened rhetoric and actions from both sides come amid a backdrop of longstanding hostilities, with each nation maintaining a fraught relationship characterized by mutual distrust and military posturing. As tensions escalate, the international community watches closely, wary of potential conflict in an already volatile region.

The implications of this "execution list" could further complicate the already delicate dynamics in the Middle East, emphasizing the ongoing cycle of threats and counter-threats that characterize Israeli-Iranian relations.



Nasrallah And Netanyahu Agreed To Ceasefire: Lebanon Minister

Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah and Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu reportedly reached an agreement for a ceasefire just hours before Nasrallah was killed in an Israeli airstrike in Beirut, according to Lebanon's Foreign Minister Abdallah Bou Habib. In an interview with PBS, Bou Habib stated that the decision to cease hostilities had received full backing from Lebanon and was communicated to both the United States and France.

Nasrallah was killed on September 27 when Israeli bombs struck his bunker. Although Hezbollah did not officially confirm the cause of death, reports indicated he succumbed to blunt trauma from the blasts. Bou Habib detailed that Nasrallah had agreed to a ceasefire with Netanyahu, a decision that involved consultations with Hezbollah and was communicated to American and French officials.

"The Lebanese House Speaker, Mr. Nabih Berri, consulted with Hezbollah, and we informed the Americans and the French about the agreement. They confirmed that Netanyahu also agreed to the statement issued by both presidents," he explained.

Prior to these developments, the U.S., France, and other allies had prepared a 21-day ceasefire plan, initiated on September 25 following a meeting between President Joe Biden and President Emmanuel Macron during the UN General Assembly in New York. However, Netanyahu rejected the ceasefire agreement the next day, instructing the military to continue its operations.

In the days leading up to Nasrallah's death, Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei advised him to flee the country, highlighting the precarious situation he faced.

Kamala Harris's Campaign Faces Challenges with Muslim and Arab Voters

A senior adviser to Vice President Kamala Harris met with American Muslim and Arab leaders on Wednesday as her presidential campaign seeks to regain support from voters frustrated with U.S. backing for Israel amid ongoing conflicts in Gaza and Lebanon. Phil Gordon, Harris's national security adviser, communicated the administration's stance during a virtual meeting, emphasizing support for a ceasefire in Gaza, diplomatic efforts in Lebanon, and stability in the Israeli-occupied West Bank.

However, community leaders like Ali Dagher, a Lebanese-American attorney, expressed skepticism about the outreach, stating, "It's too little, too late." Dagher, who did not participate in the meeting, reflected broader sentiments among constituents disillusioned with the current administration's handling of the Israel-Palestine situation.

As Harris, a Democrat, prepares to face former President Donald Trump on November 5, polls indicate a competitive race. President Joe Biden, who previously secured a significant portion of Muslim and Arab votes in 2020, has seen a notable decline in support among these communities during Israel's military actions against Hamas in Gaza. Activists argue that both Biden and Harris have not done enough to address the humanitarian



crisis unfolding in the region.

According to Palestinian health authorities, the Israeli military offensive has resulted in over 41,000 Palestinian deaths. The violence escalated following an incursion by Hamas on October 7, 2023, which Israel claims resulted in around 1,200 fatalities and approximately 250 abductions. Gaza is currently facing a severe humanitarian crisis, with nearly all of its 2 million residents displaced and widespread hunger.

In Lebanon, over 1,900 individuals have died, with thousands more injured due to ongoing cross-border clashes between Israel and Hezbollah. The rising death toll has heightened tensions within the community.

Tim Walz and JD Vance Engage in Civil Vice Presidential Debate

In a notable event, Democratic Vice Presidential candidate Tim Walz and his Republican counterpart JD Vance faced off in a debate on Wednesday, capturing the attention of millions of Americans ahead of the November 5 election. Unlike the often contentious presidential debates, this vice-presidential encounter was marked by a calm, structured, and surprisingly civil atmosphere, with both candidates primarily focusing on policy issues rather than personal attacks.

Throughout the debate, Walz and Vance opted to critique the opposing presidential candidates rather than engage in slanderous remarks, which was a refreshing change after a long, divisive election season characterized by personal insults, derogatory language, and inflammatory rhetoric. Both candidates, who have previously exchanged barbs during the campaign, maintained a respectful tone, showcasing their ability to engage in a more dignified discourse.

However, the debate did experience some heated moments, particularly when Vance was questioned about his stance on Donald



Trump and the legitimacy of the 2020 election. Vance, known for his refusal to acknowledge Biden's victory, sidestepped the inquiry about whether he would challenge the outcome of this year's election if Trump were to lose again.

Walz seized on this evasiveness, linking Vance's reluctance to Trump's unfounded claims of voter fraud, which fueled the violent attack on the U.S. Capitol on January 6, 2021. "He is still saying he (Trump) didn't lose the election," Walz asserted, directly pressing Vance with the question, "Did he (Trump) lose the 2020 election?"

Is Konda Surekha Digging Congress’s Political Grave in Telangana?



TPN, Prudhvi Gagarin: Telangana Minister Konda Surekha’s controversial comments about KT Rama Rao (KTR) and actress Samantha Ruth Prabhu have triggered widespread outrage, with strong reactions from the public and film industry figures alike. Many celebrities condemned her remarks, calling for a public apology, which Surekha ultimately issued, stating that her words were spoken in the heat of the moment and not intended to harm any family.

However, the damage seems to have already been done. This incident highlights the increasing personal attacks and the low point that political discourse in Telangana has reached in recent months. Leaders are frequently crossing the line, resorting to character assassination, and Surekha’s remarks about a fellow

woman have taken these attacks to an alarming level.

The situation mirrors a similar controversy in Andhra Pradesh, where leaders of the YSR Congress Party (YCP) made inappropriate comments about Nara Bhuvaneshwari, the wife of opposition leader Chandrababu Naidu. At the time, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy did not take action against those responsible, a decision that later became a factor in YCP’s declining popularity.

Now, Surekha’s comments have put Congress in a precarious position. While she has retracted her statements, the damage to both her reputation and the party’s image is evident. By dragging in members of the film industry in her critique of political rival KTR, Surekha has overstepped boundaries, especially

considering that her remarks targeted another woman, which has intensified the public backlash.

The spotlight is now on Telangana Congress chief and Chief Minister candidate Revanth Reddy, who is under pressure to address the controversy. His response, or lack thereof, will have significant consequences for Congress. If he fails to take decisive action, as YS Jagan did during the Bhuvaneshwari episode, it could be seen as tacit approval of such behavior and may further damage Congress’s credibility.

The way Revanth Reddy handles this situation will be crucial in determining whether Congress can recover from the fallout, or if this controversy will accelerate its decline in Telangana’s political landscape.

On Coordinated Efforts By Certain NGOs Against Indian Businesses

The Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) of 2010, and its subsequent amendments, were established to regulate foreign funding of individuals, associations, and companies in India, ensuring that such funds are not misused for activities detrimental to national interests. However, recent investigations and scrutiny of several high-profile NGOs have raised serious questions about how foreign contributions are utilized and whether some organizations are deviating from their stated goals.

When the UPA government amended the FCRA in 2010, it did so with the awareness that some influential NGOs with external connections were involved in activities that raised concerns for national security and developmental interests. Yet, despite initial recognition of the problem, significant action was not taken against these organizations at the time. NGOs, especially those receiving large foreign donations, wielded substantial financial power and often enjoyed backing from influential sections of society, including the media, academia, and political circles. Many in power feared that cracking down on these organizations would be perceived as an attack on civil liberties.

This dynamic changed following the election of the Modi government in 2014, which ushered in a renewed sense of national pride and development. The government

emphasized economic growth and security, leading to greater scrutiny of NGOs that appeared to be hindering these goals. The growing concerns were that some NGOs were not merely advocating for human rights or environmental protection, but were involved in stalling key infrastructure and industrial projects, often supported by foreign interests.

For instance, a recent investigation by the Income Tax Department revealed that from 2015 to 2021, NGOs such as Care India, Oxfam, and the Environics Trust received the vast majority of their funding from foreign sources. The concern isn’t foreign funding per se, but the potential misuse of these funds to undermine India’s economic interests. In Oxfam India’s case, investigations pointed to their involvement in campaigns to halt Adani Group’s projects in Australia, suggesting collusion with foreign entities under the guise of charitable activities. The allegations pointed toward a coordinated effort among some NGOs to disrupt economic projects, creating law and order issues and hindering India’s growth.

The growing influence of foreign-funded NGOs in disrupting major developmental projects through litigation and protests has also raised alarm bells. Projects such as those by Adani Group and JSW have been stalled due to legal challenges initiated by NGOs, often under the pretext of environmen-

tal or civil rights concerns. These activities have delayed infrastructure developments, affecting economic progress and employment generation. According to investigations, some NGOs have gone so far as to re-route funds through “puppet NGOs” when their FCRA licenses are revoked, continuing their campaigns under different guises.

The government has responded by tightening the regulations under the FCRA, with the Ministry of Home Affairs cancelling or allowing the expiration of thousands of NGO licenses. As of now, over 20,000 NGOs have lost their FCRA licenses, reflecting the government’s firm stance on ensuring transparency and accountability in foreign-funded activities. However, each time a crackdown occurs, left-leaning groups and some intellectual circles claim that these actions curb freedom of speech and dissent. The broader question remains: is the government merely targeting NGOs for political reasons, or is it justified in its efforts to safeguard national interests? The evidence suggests that while NGOs play a vital role in civil society, there are instances where some organizations misuse their platforms and foreign funding to serve agendas that conflict with India’s developmental goals. 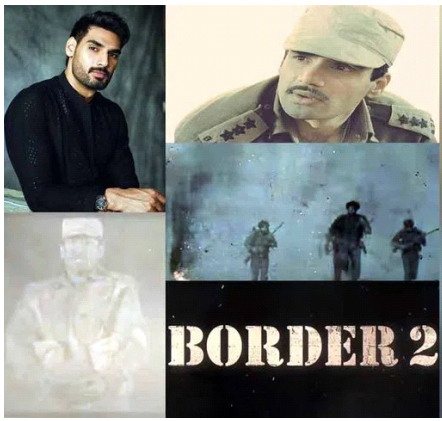
