

In Jammu and Kashmir, which saw its first assembly elections after a decade due to delimitation, the Congress-National Conference alliance is projected to win 43 out of 90 seats, three short of the majority. The BJP is expected to win 26 seats, far from the majority required to form the government. Mehbooba Mufti's Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) is likely to win 8 seats and could play a decisive role as a potential kingmaker, although Mufti has ruled out any tie-up with the BJP, signaling interest in a "secular alliance."

Despite these projections, exit polls have been known to miscalculate actual results, and the final outcome could differ. The elections in Jammu and Kashmir hold significant interest due to the potential for a hung assembly, which could lead to intense post-election negotiations.

He shared that 73 railway stations across the state are undergoing modernization, with Vijayawada railway station being developed through a public-private partnership. Additionally, Jain an-

nounced that 36 new trains were introduced last year, including six Vande Bharat trains. A notable feature of the Amaravati railway line project will be the construction of a three-kilometer bridge over the Krishna River between Kothapeta and Vaddamanu, with an estimated project cost of Rs. 2,600 crores.

This new railway line is expected to greatly enhance transportation and connectivity for the people of Andhra Pradesh, driving further economic development in the region.

Mantena Ramaraju Takes Charge as APIIC Chairman



Speaking to the media during his visit to various parts of Nellore city, Minister Narayana alleged that YCP leaders arbitrarily occupied the Budameru river, leading to poor drainage management and flooding in Vijayawada. YV Subbareddy Reacts to Supreme Court Verdict on Tirumala Laddu Case

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: YV Subbareddy, YCP Rajya Sabha member and former TTD Chairman, has responded to the Supreme Court's verdict on the Tirumala Laddu adulteration case, making it clear that he does not view the decision as a personal or party victory. In a media statement, Subbareddy emphasized that the matter concerns millions of devotees, and the truth will come out through the independent Special Investigation Team (SIT) mandated by the court.

Subbareddy expressed frustration over the alliance leaders accusing him and YCP President Jagan Mohan Reddy of involvement in the laddoo adulteration. He pointed out that there were allegations of irregularities during the previous gov-



ernment and hopes that justice will prevail with the blessings of Lord Venkateswara.

According to Subbareddy, the Su-

preme Court has ordered the formation of an independent SIT, which will include two officials from the central government, two from the state, and an expert from the Food

Safety Authority. The SIT will submit its findings to the Supreme Court.

He also addressed the pain caused by the allegations from the NDA alliance, clarifying that the investigation is under the court's jurisdiction, and further comments cannot be made. Subbareddy revealed that AR Foods dairy ghee, which is at the center of the controversy, was not supplied during his tenure as TTD Chairman or during Bhumana Karunakar Reddy's term. The supply from AR Foods began after the new government took charge, and the SIT investigation will reveal during whose tenure the tenders were issued.Subbareddy concluded by stating that he is confident the Supreme Court will ensure justice.



MP Keshineni Shivanath Announces New Terminal at Vijayawada Airport



, Vijayawada: MP Keshineni TPN Shivanath announced that the new terminal at Vijayawada Airport will be operational by June 2025, following the completion of concrete work scheduled for January of the same year. He made this announcement during the Airports Advisory Committee meeting held on Saturday.

Alongside AAC Chairman MP Vallabhaneni Balashouri, Shivanath discussed strategies to expedite the construction of the new terminal and improve facilities for passengers. The committee decided to hold weekly review meetings to monitor progress on ongoing projects.

meeting, MP Shivanath highlighted the success of flight services initiated since the NDA coalition came to power, noting that they are currently operating at full capacity. He also emphasized the need to enhance connectivity to various pilgrimage sites and commercial hubs across the country.

Addressing specific operational challenges, he mentioned that the police and revenue departments would jointly assess and resolve issues related to the new terminal. He proposed introducing cab services at the airport to assist travelers coming from distant areas, ensuring a smooth transit experience once the new terminal is operational.

Shivanath remarked on the Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu's focused attention on developing the only airport in Amaravati and noted that connectivity to multiple regions has increased since Union Minister Ram Mohan Naidu took charge. He

Climate Change Forces Italy and Switzerland to Redraw Their Borders

The dramatic impact of climate change is being felt across the globe, but in the Alpine region of Europe, it has reached a point where it is reshaping not just the environment but also national boundaries. Switzerland and Italy, two nations deeply connected by the Alps, are now in the process of redefining their shared border due to the melting of glaciers, which traditionally served as natural demarcation lines.

The Role of Alpine Glaciers in Defining Borders

The majestic Alpine glaciers, particularly those around the iconic Matterhorn mountain, have long served as a natural boundary between Switzerland and Italy. These glaciers, embedded deep in the Alpine range, have historically marked the highest points on the landscape, which in turn defined where one country's territory ended and the other's began.

However, as climate change intensifies and the rate of glacier melt accelerates, these once-stable borders are shifting. Swiss glaciers, like many others around the world, are rapidly losing ice. In 2023, Swiss glaciers experienced a volume loss of approximately 4%, following a larger 6% loss in 2022. This ongoing decline in ice mass is indicative of a larger global issue, but for Switzerland and Italy, it's more than an environmental concern—it's a territorial one.

Redrawing the Border




In May 2023, Switzerland and Italy reached an agreement to redraw their border near the Matterhorn mountain, a prominent peak shared by both nations. This agreement, finalized by Switzerland in September 2023 and currently awaiting ratification from Italy, marks a significant moment in how countries are adapting to the realities of climate change. The melting glaciers have shifted the highest points on the landscape further into Italian territory, meaning Switzerland is effectively gaining land as the glaciers recede.

Though the change in land area is minor in the grand scheme of things, it symbolizes a much larger trend. Natural features that once seemed unchanging are now moving, forcing nations to reconsider how they define their geographic boundaries. This is not an isolated case. In 2006, Italy and Austria also had to modify their borders due to the shifting glaciers along their shared border.

Climate Change and Geopolitical Boundaries

The agreement **ITA** between Switzerland and Italy underscores how climate change is becoming a geopolitical issue, influencing not just national policies but also the very borders between countries. Historically, borders have



been shaped by wars, treaties, and political negotiations, but now they are being influenced by the natural world and its response to human-induced climate change.

As the glaciers retreat, the highest points of the landscape—those that once served as the clear dividing line between nations—are moving. In this case, as the glaciers on the Matterhorn shift, Switzerland is gaining a slight advantage in land area, a rare example of how a country can "grow" due to climate change. However, this is no victory. The loss of glaciers is a far greater concern for both nations, as it signals a profound environmental shift that will have far-reaching consequences beyond the adjustment of borders.

A Broader Trend

The adjustment of borders due to melting glaciers is not unique to Switzerland and Italy. The 2006 agreement between Italy and Austria demonstrated that this issue has been on the horizon for some time. The ongoing effects of climate change, particularly in re-



Tourism and Economic Impact

The Alps are a significant driver of tourism for both Switzerland and Italy, with visitors flocking to these countries for skiing, mountaineering, and other outdoor activities that are intrinsically tied to the health of the glaciers. As the glaciers retreat, not only are borders shifting, but so too is the landscape of Alpine tourism.

Ski resorts, for example, rely heavily on the presence of glaciers to maintain their slopes and attract visitors. The shrinking ice sheets mean that resorts must adapt, either by moving their operations or investing in artificial snow, which comes with its own set of environmental and financial challenges. The changing landscape can also affect hiking routes, mountaineering paths, and even the aesthetics that draw tourists to these scenic areas.

Both countries, though reliant on tourism in these regions, must now balance the immediate economic needs of their Alpine industries with the long-term implications of climate change on their natural environments. For instance, while Switzerland is gaining land as glaciers recede, this "gain" comes at the cost of losing a portion of the environment that supports its tourism-driven economy.

Congress Being Run By Gang Of Urban Naxals: PM

Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed a rally in Washim district, Maharashtra, on Saturday, sharply criticizing the Congress party, which he described as being controlled by a "gang of urban Naxals." He urged citizens to come together to combat what he termed the "dangerous agenda" of Congress.

Modi emphasized that the Congress party believes that unity among the people will thwart their plans to divide the nation. On Friday, the Srinagar-based Chinar Corps had reported the launch of a joint operation involving both the Army and local police forces to address the potential threat. The operation focused on the Gugaldhar area, which has been a hotspot for infiltration attempts in the past.

West Bengal Junior Doctors' Forum Withdraws Cease-Work but Issues Ultimatum

The West Bengal Junior Doctors' Forum commitment to addressing them. (WBJDF) announced on Friday that it would withdraw its cease-work demonstration, initially launched in response to the horrific rape and murder of a junior doctor from R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital in August. The decision comes in light of the need to prioritize the interests of the public seeking medical services at state-run hospitals.

The remaining demands include the immediate removal of the state health secretary, the introduction of a centralized referral system, and the establishment of a digital bed vacancy monitor. Additionally, the forum seeks the creation of task forces in each medical college with elected junior doctor representation, enhanced police protection in hospitals, and the filling of vacant positions for doctors, nursing staff, and health workers.

Situation Is Deep Concern For Us: India On West Asia Tensions



External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar clarified on Saturday that his upcoming visit to Pakistan is strictly for the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) Summit and not for discussions on India-Pakistan relations. Speaking at the Sardar Patel Lecture on Governance in New Delhi, he emphasized that he will be attending the SCO meeting as a "good member" of the organization.

Jaishankar confirmed his travel plans for the SCO heads of government meeting scheduled for mid-October in Islamabad, explaining that Pakistan, like India, is a relatively recent member of the bloc. He acknowledged the anticipated media interest due to the sensitive nature of India-Pakistan relations but reiterated that his focus would be on the multilateral event rather than bilateral discussions.

"The meeting is taking place in Pakistan because they are also a recent member," he said, referencing the tradition of Prime Ministers attending high-level SCO meetings. Jaishankar also indicated that he is preparing thoroughly for the summit, considering various scenarios that may arise.

The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) has officially confirmed that Jaishankar will lead India's delegation to the SCO summit on October 15-16. This visit marks the first time an Indian External Affairs Minister will travel to Pakistan since Sushma Swaraj in 2015.

Earlier this year, in May, Pakistan's Foreign Minister Bilawal Bhutto Zardari visited India for an SCO meeting in Goa, marking the first visit by a Pakistani Foreign Minister to India in six years. The SCO, founded in 2001, is a major intergovernmental organization that includes nine member states, among them India and Pakistan, as well as several observer states.

Despite this withdrawal, WBJDF representative Debasish Halder warned that junior doctors would initiate a fast-unto-death protest if their demands, which fall under the jurisdiction of the West Bengal government, are not met within 24 hours. The organization had previously outlined conditions for ending their ongoing agitation, which resumed on Tuesday.

The first of their ten demands concerns the prolonged judicial process necessary to secure justice for the victim, with fulfillment dependent on the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the would rely on the state government's

They are also calling for the formation of inquiry committees in every medical college to investigate individuals involved in threat syndicates and ensure accountability. The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) expressed deep concern regarding the escalating tensions in West Asia, particularly involving Israel, Iran, and Lebanon. MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal emphasized the importance of preventing the conflict from widening into a broader regional crisis.

In a press briefing, Jaiswal reiterated India's call for restraint among all parties involved and the need to protect civilians. He stated, "We had reiterated a call for restraint by all concerned and also the protection of civilians. It is important, in our opinion, that this conflict doesn't take a wider regional dimension." He urged that all issues be resolved through dialogue and diplomacy.

India's advisory to its nationals noted the deteriorating security situation in the region, particularly following Iran's ballistic missile attack on Israel, which prompted retaliatory actions and military engagement between Israel and Hezbollah in Lebanon. The MEA has advised Indian citizens to exercise caution and avoid non-essential travel to Iran, urging those residing there to stay vigilant and maintain contact with the Indian Embassy in Tehran.

As for repatriation, Jaiswal clarified that there are currently no evacuation processes in place for Indian nationals in Israel, Iran, or other affected countries. He stated, "As of now, flights are running from Israel, Iran, and other countries, so people have the option if they want to leave." Families have reached out to Indian embassies, but no formal evacuation efforts have been initiated.





Canada Reaffirms Strong Support for India's Territorial Integrity

The Canadian government has reiterated its firm stance on India's territorial integrity, labeling it as "absolute." David Morrison, Canada's Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs, made this statement while testifying before the foreign interference commission in Ottawa. He emphasized that Canada's policy is clear: there is only one India, and this position is unwavering.

Morrison, whose role is akin to that of India's Foreign Secretary, highlighted ongoing private discussions between Canada and India. "We have open channels and are continuing to engage with them," he remarked.

During his testimony, he acknowledged reports that Canada views certain actions by pro-Khalistan groups as "awful, but lawful," indicating a commitment to freedom of speech, even for views that may be contentious. Morrison stressed that while some activities are troubling, they are protected under Canadian law.



He also noted that the diplomatic in Surrey, British Columbia. situation has improved since September 18 of the previous year. This was a critical point when Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau raised "credible allegations" suggesting a possible connection between Indian agents and the killing of Hardeep

Climate Change Activists Stage Dramatic Protest Outside UN Agency in London

On Friday, climate activists from Ocean Rebellion staged a striking demonstration outside the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) in London, drawing attention to the environmental threats posed by Liquid Natural Gas (LNG). The protest featured a dramatic act where activists pretended to drown in oil and gas, symbolizing the peril facing the oceans.

The group, which has become a familiar presence on London's streets, staged this unsettling scene on the steps of the UN agency responsible for regulating maritime transport. One activist, adorned as an "ocean goddess," wore a fishbowl filled with black liquid, depicting a harrowing image of drowning. The visual was powerful, with the activist appearing to scream as the liquid engulfed her, only to drain away moments later.



Joe Biden requests Israel to avoid attacking Iran's oil fields

President Joe Biden has urged Israel to reconsider its military response to Iran's recent ballistic missile attack, specifically advising against strikes on Iranian oil fields. This call for restraint comes as tensions escalate in the region following Iran's launch of approximately 200 missiles at Israeli targets earlier this week.

During a press briefing at the White House, Biden acknowledged that Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is likely to respond to the attacks but emphasized the importance of avoiding actions that could lead to a broader conflict. "If I were in their shoes, I'd be thinking about other alternatives than striking oil fields," Biden remarked, highlighting concerns that an attack on critical oil infrastructure could significantly disrupt global energy markets, particularly affecting supply to countries like China. Biden's comments reflect a broader effort to manage the situation, as he noted that Israel had not yet finalized its plans for retaliation. His administration has previously cautioned against targeting Iran's nuclear facilities as well, seeking to prevent a spiral into all-out war.

Hit Iran's Nuclear Sites First Trump's **Advice To Israel**



Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump stated on Friday that he believes Israel should target Iran's nuclear facilities in response to the recent missile attacks from the Islamic Republic. Speaking at a campaign event in Fayetteville, North Carolina, Trump referenced a recent question posed to President Joe Biden regarding potential strikes against Iran's nuclear program.

At the event, Trump recalled Biden's response, which suggested restraint: "They asked him, what do you think about Iran, would you hit Iran? And he goes, 'As long as they don't hit the nuclear stuff.' That's the thing you want to hit, right?"

Trump criticized Biden's stance, asserting, "I think he's got that one wrong. Isn't that what you're supposed to hit? I mean, it's the biggest risk we have, nuclear weapons." He emphasized that if action is to be taken, it should focus on nuclear targets first.

Biden, in a statement earlier in the week, firmly opposed military strikes on Iranian nuclear sites, stating, "The answer is no," when asked if he would support such actions. He acknowledged the recent Iranian missile barrage toward Israel but underscored the importance of proportional response, saying, "We'll be discussing with the Israelis what they're going to do."

This back-and-forth comes amid heightened tensions in the Middle East, particularly following Iran's launch of nearly 200 missiles aimed at Israel. Trump, engaged in a competitive election battle against Democratic nominee Vice President Kamala Harris, has been relatively quiet on recent Middle Eastern escalations but issued a critical statement blaming Biden and Harris for the crisis.



Surrounding her were other protesters clad in gas masks and holding petrol pumps, which spewed flames, enhancing the dramatic effect of the demonstration. Ocean Rebellion shared images of the protest on X, emphasizing the urgent message behind their actions.

Pak Capital Locked Down As Imran Khan's **Supporters Try To Seize The Streets**

Pakistan's capital was heavily fortified on Saturday as security forces swarmed the city and mobile internet services were shut down. This lockdown coincided with protests by supporters of jailed former Prime Minister Imran Khan, who were determined to take to the streets despite significant government pushback.

Khan, who has been barred from participating in the upcoming February elections due to a series of legal challenges and allegations of rigging, remains a pivotal figure in Pakistani politics. His party, the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI), has defied a government crackdown, continuing to organize protests to challenge the current administration.

Supporters of PTI began their journey to Islamabad from Khan's stronghold in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on Friday, but were met with roadblocks created by shipping containers and tear gas. Despite these obstacles, small convoys of protesters made their way toward the capital on Saturday, even as the government deployed troops to



ensure security ahead of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) summit set to begin on October 15.

In a show of solidarity, Khan issued a message on social media, praising his supporters for their resilience. "I am so proud of all our people. You showed unfaltering courage as you came out yesterday and overcame unbelievable obstacles," he wrote.

In addition to the protests in Islam-

abad, demonstrations were planned in Lahore, but the main motorway linking the eastern city to the capital was blocked by security forces. Amnesty International criticized the government's actions, stating that the communication blackouts and roadblocks violate citizens' rights to free expression, peaceful assembly, and movement. They expressed concern over what they described as a disturbing trend toward suppressing the right to protest in Pakistan.

Iran's Supreme Leader **Declares Missile Strikes on** Israel as 'Legal and Legitimate'

Iran's Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei has asserted that the recent military operation against Israel was "completely legal and legitimate." He made this statement during his address to a large congregation at the weekly Friday prayers in Tehran, discussing the missile attack executed by Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) targeting Israel, as reported by Xinhua.

Khamenei described the missile strike as a necessary response to what he termed the "astonishing crimes" perpetrated by Israel and the United States in the West Asia region. He emphasized that the actions taken by the Iranian armed forces were merely the "least punishment" for Israel, highlighting Iran's commitment to responding forcefully. "We will neither hesitate nor be negligent, nor hurry in fulfilling our responsibilities," he stated.

He further clarified that any future actions would be executed at the appropriate time, based on the assessments of military and political leaders. Khamenei indicated that similar operations would continue if deemed necessary.

On Tuesday, the IRGC launched approximately 180 missiles aimed at strategic sites in Israel. This attack was presented by Iran as retaliation for the targeted assassinations of key figures, including Hamas Politburo Chief Ismail Haniyeh, Hezbollah leader Hassan Nasrallah, and senior IRGC commander Abbas Nilforoushan. Khamenei condemned these assassinations and characterized Israel's actions, supported by the U.S., as part of a broader pattern of aggression against both Lebanese and Palestinian groups.



Oil soars 10% in five days, logs biggest weekly gain in one year

Oil prices surged on Friday, marking most significant increase since January their largest weekly gains in over a year amid escalating tensions in the Middle East. Brent crude futures rose by 43 cents, settling at \$78.05 per barrel, while U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude increased by 67 cents to close at \$74.38 per barrel.

The uptick in prices was driven by the threat of regional conflict following a missile barrage from Iran aimed at Israel. Israel has vowed to retaliate, escalating fears of broader warfare. Despite the surge in oil prices—nearly 2% at one point-gains were tempered after U.S. President Joe Biden suggested that Israel should consider alternatives to attacking Iranian oil facilities.

Earlier in the week, oil prices had jumped over 5% after Biden confirmed that the U.S. was in discussions with Israel regarding a potential strike on Iranian energy infrastructure. For the week, Brent crude gained over 8%, its 2023, while WTI saw a 9.1% rise, the largest since March 2023.

Analysts from JPMorgan indicated that while an Israeli strike on Iranian energy facilities might not be the preferred option, the current low levels of global oil inventories—at 4.4 billion barrels, the lowest on record—could keep prices elevated until the situation stabilizes. Brokerage StoneX warned that if Iranian oil infrastructure were targeted, prices could spike by \$3 to \$5 per barrel. Amid these tensions, Iran's Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei publicly called for increased resistance against Israel. Iranian officials have threatened to target Israeli energy installations in retaliation for any attacks, highlighting the risks to the region's oil supply. Iran, a member of OPEC, produces around 3.2 million barrels per day, or 3% of global output. Analysts noted that OPEC's spare production capacity could mitigate potential disruptions to Iranian supplies.

State Bank of India (SBI) has declared the loan accounts of the debt-laden state-owned telecom firm MTNL as sub-standard non-performing assets (NPAs) due to ongoing non-payment of installments and interest. According to a regulatory filing by MTNL, as of September 30, the total outstanding on its loan account was ₹325.52 crore, as detailed in an SBI letter dated October 1.

The declaration took effect on September 28, 2024, and was triggered by the firm's failure to make necessary payments since June 30. SBI's letter indicates that the specific

loan account (Term Loan Account Additionally, the public sector bank Number 36726658903) has now been categorized under the NPA – Sub Standard classification. This classification applies to accounts with a default period of less than 12 months, suggesting they may have the potential to clear their dues.

As of the latest update, ₹281.62 crore of MTNL's loan is overdue and requires immediate payment to regularize the account. SBI has also requested clarification regarding the government's assurances to cover MTNL's outstanding dues.

is seeking updates on various monetization projects that MTNL is pursuing, including a significant agreement with NBCC to develop 13.88 acres of land into residential and commercial properties. This move could potentially generate revenue and help address the telecom firm's financial challenges.

The situation underscores the ongoing difficulties faced by MTNL, which has struggled with financial stability amid increasing competition in the telecom sector.

Jio Financial Services Ltd (JFS), a subsidiary of Reliance Industries led by Mukesh Ambani, announced on October 4 that the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has granted in-principle approval for JFS and BlackRock Financial Management to co-sponsor a new mutual fund. The final registration approval will be contingent upon the fulfillment of specific requirements outlined by SEBI.

This announcement follows the July 26, 2023, agreement between JFS and Black-Rock to establish "Jio BlackRock," a joint venture with equal stakes from both companies. This collaboration marks BlackRock's return to the Indian financial market after its exit in 2018.

India's per-capita income almost doubling: Nirmala Sitharaman

At the Kautilya Economic Conclave in New Delhi on Friday, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman expressed optimism about India's economic future, predicting that per capita income could nearly double within the next five years. She highlighted that the ongoing growth of the economy will contribute significantly to rising living standards, marking a transformative era for the average Indian.

Citing data from the International Monetary Fund (IMF), Sitharaman noted that the current per capita income stands at \$2,730 (approximately ₹2.29 lakh) and could increase by an additional \$2,000 (around ₹1.68 lakh) in just five years. She emphasized that while India is poised for steady economic expansion, In her speech, Sitharaman also outlined key challenges in the global landscape could im-

pact this growth trajectory.

"The global backdrop is no longer the same," she stated, acknowledging both the potential challenges and opportunities presented by the current international environment. Sitharaman pointed out that the Indian economy must adapt to these changing dynamics, particularly as Prime Minister Narendra Modi aims to transform India into a developed nation by 2047—marking a century since independence. Achieving this ambitious goal would require sustained growth rates exceeding 8% over the next 25 years, economists suggest, alongside efforts to bridge the existing inequality gap.

Impact of Iran-Israel Conflict on India's Basmati Rice Exports



The ongoing conflict between Iran and Israel has begun to cast a shadow on India's agricultural export market, specifically impacting its famed basmati rice industry. Iran, one of the major importers of Indian basmati rice, has been at the center of the conflict, creating uncertainty and slowing down the demand for this essential commodity. This disruption has already caused significant ripples in India's domestic grain markets, particularly in Uttar Pradesh, which is a key region for basmati rice production.

Slump in Paddy Prices

In the grain market of Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad, one of the key hubs for basmati rice, the effects of the Iran-Israel conflict have become starkly visible. The price of the Paddy (Dhan) Basmati 1509 variety, a popular variant for exports, has dropped significantly. Over the past two days, prices have decreased by ₹200 to ₹300 per quintal. The current price for this variety has fallen to ₹2,700 per quintal, down from the ₹3,500 per quintal it commanded last year.

the halt in export insurance. Insurance companies have stopped providing coverage for exports to Iran due to the heightened risk caused by the conflict. Without insurance, exporters are unable to ship their rice to Iran, effectively cutting off a crucial market.

Bhalotia and other industry leaders have called on the Indian government to intervene. They are urging the government to negotiate with insurance companies to provide coverage for exports to Iran and Iraq. "We request the government to ask the insurance companies to give us insurance so that we can continue some level of exports and ensure fair prices for our farmers' produce," Bhalotia said.

Recent Developments in Basmati Rice Exports

It is worth noting that just last month, India removed the minimum export price (MEP) for basmati rice in an effort to boost exports. The MEP had been seen as a barrier to selling certain grades of basmati rice, particularly in markets across the Middle East, Europe, and the Americas. The removal of the MEP was expected to create more opportunities for global buyers, allowing them access to a wider range of basmati rice options from India.

Monetary Policy Committee (MPC): A Crucial Body in **India's Economic Policy**

The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) is an essential decision-making body responsible for formulating India's monetary policy, specifically determining key interest rates that directly impact inflation and economic growth. The central government recently reconstituted the MPC by appointing three new external members for a period of four years, reinforcing its role in guiding India's economic trajectory.

What is the MPC?

The MPC is a statutory body established under Section 45ZB of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Act, 1934, which was amended in May 2016 to provide a legal mandate for the committee. Its primary responsibility is to set the policy interest rate required to achieve the inflation target, which is crucial for ensuring price stability and fostering sustainable growth.

Composition of the MPC


The MPC consists of six members, with equal representation from the RBI and the central government. These six members include:

- The RBI Governor, who serves as the ex-officio Chairperson of the committee.

- The Deputy Governor of the RBI in charge of monetary policy.
- One officer of the RBI, nominated by the Central Board of the RBI.

- Three external members, appointed by the central government. These external members are independent economists or financial experts who bring diverse perspectives to the committee.

The external members are appointed for a period of four years and cannot be reappointed. This mix of government-nominated members and RBI representatives ensures that the committee has a balanced view of both governmental policy goals and central banking objectives.

The All India Rice Exporters Association (AIREA) has raised alarms about the situation. Ajay Bhalotia, the General Secretary of AIREA, has warned that the conflict is putting India's basmati rice industry in jeopardy. "Of the total basmati rice exported from India, 25% is exported to Iran, while 20% goes to Iraq. The combined value of these exports amounts to over two million tonnes, valued at more than \$2 billion," he explained.

The prospect of losing this substantial market has left farmers and exporters anxious. If exports to Iran and Iraq come to a halt, it will severely impact farmers' profits, with some expecting to lose nearly half of their earnings.

Another notable record was set by Christopher Sander from the United States, who cracked open 18 eggs with one hand in just 30 seconds.

In 2024 alone, Jaiswal is the third-highest run-getter, racking up 929 runs in eight Tests, showcasing his consistency. He was instrumental in India's recent seven-wicket victory over Bangladesh, scoring 72 runs off 51 balls in the first innings and 51 off 45 in the second, embodying the aggressive batting philosophy reminiscent of England's 'Bazball.'

Romelu Lukaku continued to impress for Napoli, scoring once and providing two assists in a commanding 3-1 victory over Como on Friday.
