AP CM Chandrababu Naidu Met PM Modi, **Discussed Key State Issues in Delhi**



TPN, New Delhi: Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu is currently on a visit to Delhi, where he met Prime Minister Narendra Modi to address various critical issues affecting the state. He noted that in the past decade, approximately 13,000 left-wing extremists have surrendered their weapons and reintegrated into society. This trend reflects a diminishing support base for Naxal groups, which he attributed to the effective strategies implemented by the government.

Shah urged remaining Maoists to surrender and take advantage of the rehabilitation schemes offered by the central government. He acknowledged that a large proportion-80 percent-of Naxal operatives are concentrated in Chhattisgarh, indicating a focus for future operations.

The Union Minister expressed confidence that the final confrontation against left-wing extremism is on the horizon. He reiterated the government's commitment to restoring peace and stability in affected regions. Shah's remarks underscore the significant strides taken to address this long-standing issue, as the government aims to eliminate the threat of Maoist violence in the coming years. As the nation approaches this critical juncture, the emphasis will be on dismantling the remaining structures of left-wing extremism and fostering an environment conducive to development and security.

Former YCP MP Nandigam Suresh **Remanded for 14 Days in**

Home Minister Anitha Warns YCP Over Politicization of Punganur Girl's Murder Case

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Andhra Pradesh Home Minister Vangalapudi Anita has warned the YSR Congress Party (YCP) against politicizing the tragic murder of a six-year-old girl in Punganur, Chittoor district. The minister revealed that the police have successfully cracked the case and arrested three suspects, with 12 special police teams working diligently to find the girl, Aspia, who was reported missing on September 29. Unfortunately, her body was found in a storage tank on October 2.

The Home Minister expressed her deep sorrow over the incident, describing it as heart-wrenching. She also clarified that, according to the postmortem report, the child was not raped, dismissing the false rumors circulating about the nature of the crime. Anita criticized YCP



leaders for attempting to politicize the case, accusing them of spreading misinformation to gain political leverage.

She further highlighted that while hundreds of rape cases occurred during the YCP's tenure, Chief Min-

ister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy had not taken proactive steps. "Jagan did not leave Tadepalli Palace even once during those incidents," Anita remarked, taking aim at the YCP leadership. She strongly urged the YCP to refrain from using the sensitive case of the child's mur-

der for political purposes, warning that any further attempts to do so would be met with resistance.

Minister Anita also stated that Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu had personally spoken with the grieving family and assured them of full support. She vowed that those responsible for the crime, as well as those spreading false narratives on social media, would be severely punished.

Supporting Anita's stance, another minister, Ramprasad Reddy, expressed deep sadness over the child's death and emphasized that the government stands firmly with the victim's family. He reiterated that the accused would face strict punishment, and he condemned YCP leaders for allegedly using the tragedy for political gain.

YCP Spokesperson Shyamala Satirizes Chandrababu Naidu and Pawan Kalyan

Woman's Murder Case



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former YSR Congress Party (YCP) MP Nandigam Suresh finds himself in deeper legal trouble as he has been remanded for 14 days in connection with the 2020 murder of a woman named Mariamma in Velagapudi, Tullur mandal. The police recently produced Suresh in the Mangalagiri court, where the judge remanded him until October 21.

Nandigam Suresh, already facing legal issues in a separate case involving an attack on the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) office, has now been implicated in the Mariamma murder case. In 2020, Mariamma was brutally murdered, and after further investigations, Suresh was linked to the crime.

The police, seeking a Prisoner's Transit (PT) warrant for further questioning related to this case, were granted approval by the court. Following the court's decision, Suresh was sent to Guntur Jail, where he was already being held for his alleged involvement in the TDP office attack.

This recent remand adds to the growing legal challenges facing the former YCP leader, raising concerns about his future in politics.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The YSR Congress Party (YCP) has responded strongly to the tragic killing of a young girl in Punganur, Chittoor district. YCP spokesperson and anchor Shyamala posted a scathing video on X (formerly Twitter), directing her harsh criticisms at opposition leaders, including TDP Chief Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy CM Pawan Kalyan. She condemned the coalition government's handling of the state's law and order, especially concerning the safety of women.

In her video, Shyamala ridiculed the leaders for their failures. She accused the government of failing to protect the citizens despite making lofty promises during the elections. "The darkness of the new moon has shrouded the state like a full moon. In this country where girls once roamed freely, only Andhra Pradesh is suffering under the rule of a coalition that came to



power with false guarantees," Shyamala commented.

She further targeted Pawan Kalyan with sharp words, "Poshetti who slapped Poddu ten times...

What do you say about the Punganur incident? Sammy, who came to power with movie dialogues like 'Annaiya Annawante Eduravana,' is silent as leaders under this alliance commit atrocities and rapes."

Shyamala didn't hold back in criticizing Chandrababu Naidu either. She pointed out that, despite the incident happening in his own district, he remained indifferent. "The lives of our girls are at stake, yet you feel nothing. This alliance, which once boasted of bringing Rama Rajya, has instead turned it into a Ravana Rajya," she concluded.

Shyamala's remarks have added fuel to the ongoing political debate over the safety of women under the current administration and highlighted the growing tensions between YCP and the opposition.

Duvvada Srinivas With Her Girlfriend Madhuri In Tirumala



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former YSR Tirumala temple, marked his first Congress Party (YCP) leader and MLC Duvvada Srinivas, from the Tekkali constituency of Srikakulam district, has found himself at the center of attention once again after being spotted with his girlfriend Madhuri in Tirumala. The sighting, which occurred during a morning break darshan at the

public appearance in nearly a month following personal and political controversies.

Duvvada Srinivas has been notably quiet due to an ongoing dispute with his wife, Duvvada Vani, who alleged that Srinivas had distanced himself from their family and

was living with another woman. This claim, alongside a property dispute, created a stir. After several weeks of remaining out of the public eye, Srinivas and Madhuri appeared together, and the couple addressed the media afterward.

the party's image.

After losing the election to TDP's Achchennaidu and facing mounting personal issues, Vani publicly revealed that Srinivas had been living with Madhuri for several years. This revelation led to further discussions about the division of assets. It is believed that the issue was settled after intervention from key figures, allowing Srinivas and Madhuri to resume their life together.

Duvvada Srinivas has since clarified that he will no longer be with Vani and intends to remain with Madhuri, despite the demands put forward by Vani during their dispute. The controversy resurfaced when the couple was seen together at Tirumala, reigniting media attention around their relationship and Srinivas' political standing.

Fraud At Guntur, 57 Victims Duped of Rs. 14 **Crores Through Fake Job Offers**

TPN, Guntur: A shocking case of fraud has come to light, where around 57 individuals from the Telugu states were swindled out of Rs. 14 crores through fake job offer letters promising employment in Britain. The fraudulent scheme was allegedly orchestrated by a group led by Krishna Chaitanya, a close associate of MLC Lella Appireddy, under the guise of Vishnu Overseas Consultancy, which was set up in Ashok Nagar, Guntur, last year.

Key players involved in the scam reportedly included Krishna Chaitanya from Polaluru Road in Guntur, Lakshmishetty Jayaram from Akulavaritota, Guntur, Eidara Manohar from Nadendla Mandal, and Kongara Gopikrishna from Narukupadu. Gopikrishna, who was employed in Britain, played a pivotal role in con-



vincing victims that they would receive job visas abroad. Several victims shared their distressing stories. Edwin William Sam Richards from Guntur's Inner Ring Road was defrauded of Rs. 23 lakhs, while Karreddula Sarath Chandra from Nellore was cheated out of Rs. 8 lakhs. Anil Reddy from Machars, who paid Rs. 18 lakhs, had his passport banned for 10 years after applying twice with a fake job letter.

Many victims hailed from regions like Mangapet, Dilsook Nagar, Sarur Nagar, Mahabubabad, Piduguralla, Narukulapadu, Ongole, and Kothapally, covering both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Victims also alleged that they faced threats and police complaints when they demanded the return of their money, with some accusing prominent leaders from the previous YCP government of providing protection to the fraudsters.

The victims are now appealing to Minister Nara Lokesh and Home Minister Anita Vangalapudi for justice. They are calling for a thorough investigation into the fake job offer scam, believing that a deeper probe could expose more of those involved in the fraudulent operation.

Jayalakshmi emphasized the importance of clarity in the report, instructing that it should distinctly categorize legally registered lands alongside those that have violated regulations. She urged the officials to re-examine the previously submitted details to ensure accuracy and thoroughness.

The report is expected to provide a clear understanding of the land status, including all necessary documentation of registered lands. This initiative aims to ensure compliance with land regulations and maintain the integrity of land management practices.

Superintendent of the Land Acquisition Section, Durga Prasad, was also present during the conference, contributing to the discussion on the ongoing efforts to streamline land administration across the state.

The conflict between Israel and Hamas has escalated dra-**I** matically over the past year, leading to profound devastation in Gaza. Following a surprise attack by Hamas on October 7, 2023, Israel launched a full-scale air-ground invasion that has since resulted in over 40,000 fatalities. This escalation was marked by Hamas's "Operation Al Aqsa Flood," which involved a coordinated assault that claimed the lives of over 1,200 people in Israel, catching the country off guard.

India Advances Deep-Sea Mining With Varaha-3, Collecting Key **Polymetallic Nodules**



The National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT) has launched exploratory trials in the Andaman Sea using the Varaha-3, a specialized seabed mining machine. Conducted at a depth of 1,193 meters, these trials are part of India's broader initiative to explore and responsibly harness ocean resources. The Geological Survey of India had previously surveyed the trial sites, identifying them as potential hotspots for valuable mineral resources, particularly polymetallic nodules.

During the trials, Varaha-3 successfully collected polymetallic nodules ranging from 60 to 120 mm in size. These nodules are rich in essential metals such as nickel, cobalt, and copper, which are vital for various industries, especially those focused on renewable energy and electric vehicle production. This successful collection marks a significant advancement in India's capabilities for deep-sea mining.

This initiative includes an integrated mining system designed to enhance the efficiency of nodule extraction and transportation while safeguarding marine ecosystems.

Indian Army Recovers Huge Cache Of Weapons, Ammunition From Manipur

In a coordinated operation involving the Indian Army, Assam Rifles, Manipur Police, and other security forces, 18 weapons, ammunition, and warlike stores were successfully recovered in Manipur from October 4 to October 6. This initiative reflects the ongoing efforts to enhance security in the region.

The operation commenced on October 4 when the Assam Rifles and Manipur Police executed a joint search in the Khengmol area of Churachandpur district. Their efforts led to the recovery of a 9 mm pistol, five single-barrel rifles, and five improvised heavy mortars, showcasing the effectiveness of their collaboration.

On October 5, based on specific intelligence regarding insurgent activities in the Kakching district, the Indian Army, Assam Rifles, and Manipur Police conducted a thorough search in the Turulmamai area. This operation yielded three carbine machine guns, a 9 mm pistol, two single-barrel rifles, hand grenades, and additional warlike materials, further contributing to the security efforts in the region.



The following day, October 6, another intelligence-based operation in Singtom village of Kakching district resulted in the recovery of a sten machine carbine, a 9 mm country-made pistol, grenades, ammunition, and other military supplies, highlighting the sustained focus on neutralizing insurgent threats.

In Thoubal district, a joint operation on October 5 led by the Assam Rifles and Manipur Police in Chingkham

Ching resulted in the recovery of a carbine machine gun, a 32 mm pistol, grenades, and ammunition. This reflects the comprehensive approach taken by the security forces to secure the area.

Additionally, during an area domination patrol in Thamlapokpi village of Tegnoupal district on October 6, a team from the Indian Army recovered a grenade and more warlike stores.

Speaking during an event for youth who completed a hospitality training program under the Centre's 'Hunar Se Rozgar Tak' initiative, Singh highlighted the hardships faced by the state's residents due to the ongoing crisis.

"The people of Manipur have endured

significant challenges, but with God's blessing, those affected are starting to return to their original places," Singh remarked. He stressed the necessity of fostering peace and resolving issues through non-violent means, urging the public to steer clear of further violence.

The Chief Minister also noted the government's ongoing efforts to assist the youth, stating that approximately 400 young individuals have either completed or are currently undergoing training under the tourism ministry's scheme, with 169 already securing placements in various cities. Among those trained are 78 individuals who were displaced due to the recent unrest.

Singh elaborated on a specific training program in perfumery, attended by 30 youths, including 15 who had been displaced. "We will prioritize selecting 2,000 trainees, especially those residing in relief camps," he stated, highlighting the government's commitment to supporting those most affected.

Delhi CM Atishi To Repair 89 Damaged **Roads Before Assembly Elections**

Delhi Chief Minister Atishi announced on Monday that the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government will resume various public works, including road repairs, that were reportedly stalled by the BJP while AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal was incarcerated. At a press conference, Atishi stated that her government aims to repair damaged roads ahead of the assembly elections scheduled for early next year.

To kick off this initiative, the government has identified 89 damaged Public Works Department (PWD) roads that require strengthening. Atishi revealed that 74 tenders have already been floated to expedite the repair process.

During the press conference, Kejriwal also spoke, expressing his frustration with the BJP's actions while he was in jail. He stated, "When I was in jail, these people (BJP) stalled various works of the Delhi government. After I returned, I and Atishi inspected the roads and saw they were not in good condition. I wrote to her and requested that Atishi ji get these roads maintained with immediate effect."

Atishi further elaborated on the repair works, mentioning that a total of 6,671 potholes had



been identified during a series of inspections. Of these, 3,454 patches have already been filled, showcasing the government's commitment to improving road conditions in the capital.

The decision to restart these works comes as part of AAP's broader strategy to demonstrate their responsiveness to public infrastructure needs and to address any grievances stemming from stalled projects. As the elections approach, these efforts may be seen as critical in reinforcing AAP's governance credentials among voters in Delhi.

Will Implement NRC In Jharkhand: **Union Minister Shivraj Chouhan**

As political tensions escalate in Jharkhand ahead of upcoming elections, Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan, the BJP's in-charge for the state, announced on Monday the party's intention to implement the National Register of Citizens (NRC). He criticized the Chief Minister Hemant Soren-led government for allegedly favoring infiltrators and compromising the state's demographic integrity.

During a statement to ANI, Chouhan stressed the BJP's commitment to safeguarding the interests of local residents, emphasizing the mantra of "Roti, Mati aur Beti." He pointed out that the tribal population in the Santhal region has dramatically decreased from over 44% to 28%, attributing this change to the influx of Bangladeshi infiltrators.

Chouhan accused Soren's government of engaging in vote bank politics by supporting these infiltrators, stating, "We will implement the NRC in Jharkhand, ensuring that local residents are registered while intruders are identified and removed."

On October 5, the BJP unveiled its election manifesto, titled 'Paanch Prana,' which focuses on



youth and women's welfare in Jharkhand. The manifesto outlines five key promises: Yuva Sathi, Gogo Didi Yojana, Ghar Saakar, Laxmi Johar, and 'Assured Employment.'

The Gogo Didi Yojana pledges monthly financial assistance of ₹2,100 to women, while the 'Assured Employment' initiative commits to creating 5 lakh jobs over five years. The Ghar Saakar promise aims to provide housing for all, and the Yuva Sathi scheme offers ₹2,000 to youth preparing for competitive exams. The BJP also plans to fill over 200,000 vacant posts, with the recruitment process expected to commence in the first cabinet meeting, aiming to complete 100,000 government recruitments by 2025.

In another distressing development, a Russian airstrike in the southern Ukrainian city of Kherson injured 17 people, including a two-year-old boy and a four-year-old girl. Regional authorities confirmed that four bombs were dropped on the city during the attack, highlighting the ongoing human cost of the conflict.



Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine 2024 Awarded to MicroRNA Researchers

The 2024 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine has been awarded to American scientists Victor Ambros and Gary Ruvkun for their pioneering research on microRNA, which has significantly advanced our understanding of gene regulation and the complexity of life.

Their discoveries elucidate how microRNAs control gene expression, enabling the differentiation of various cell types within organisms, including humans. Despite all human cells sharing the same genetic blueprint, microRNAs play a crucial role in determining how these cells develop into distinct forms and functions, from nerve cells to liver cells.

The Nobel Assembly at Sweden's Karolinska Institute announced that the



prize is part of a fund worth 11 million Swedish kronor (approximately £810,000).

Ambros and Ruvkun were the first to identify microRNAs and reveal their essential role in gene regulation for multicellular organisms. Their research demon-

for over 1,000 microRNAs, which are critical for the development of complex life forms. Abnormal microRNA regulation is linked to various health issues, including cancer and congenital disorders such as hearing loss.

strated that the human genome codes The researchers conducted their groundbreaking work using the nematode worm *C. elegans*, investigating a mutant strain that failed to develop certain cell types. They discovered that microRNAs were vital for the worm's proper development by inhibiting spe-

cific messenger RNAs (mRNAs), thereby preventing certain genes from being expressed.

Prof. Janosch Heller from Dublin City University expressed his delight at the recognition, noting that their work has paved the way for innovative therapies for diseases like epilepsy and has illuminated the intricate mechanisms controlling cellular processes.

This year's award adds to the illustrious history of Nobel laureates in the field of physiology and medicine, following previous winners such as Katalin Kariko and Drew Weissman in 2023 for their work on mRNA technology, and Svante Paabo in 2022 for his contributions to human evolution.



The company markets two cement brands, Mycem and Zuari, as it navigates the competitive landscape.

The Indian rupee rose by 2 paise to 83.97 L against the US dollar in early trade on Monday, buoyed by a weaker dollar in the international markets and declining crude oil prices. 



IAF Shoots Down 'Chinese Spy Balloon' Target: **A Show of Strength and Preparedness**

This operation took place under the Eastern Air Command's jurisdiction, with a Rafale fighter jet executing the mission at over 55,000 feet. Largest Brain Map Unveils 140,000 Neurons in Fruit Fly

Ccientists have unveiled the most **J**comprehensive map of a fruit fly's brain to date, detailing nearly 140,000 neurons and an astonishing 54.5 million synapses. This groundbreaking achievement is the result of over four years of dedicated work by a research team led by neuroscientists Mala Murthy and Sebastian Seung at Princeton University. The map, termed a 'connectome,' represents the most complete brain diagram produced for any organism so far.

In total, the research team and volunteers made over three million manual edits to ensure the map's accuracy. This meticulous process revealed 8,453 distinct neuron types, of which 4,581 were previously unknown to science.

Among the surprising findings, researchers discovered intriguing details about the interconnections between neurons. They observed that neurons typically involved in sensory processing—particularly visual circuits—often connect to neurons responsible for other senses, including hearing and touch. This discovery underscores the complex integration of sensory information within the fruit fly's brain.

The data derived from this extensive mapping

has already been applied to simulate fruit fly behavior in virtual models. In one experiment, the simulation demonstrated how neurons responsible for detecting sweet or bitter tastes activated motor neurons that control the fly's proboscis. Remarkably, when tested on live flies, the virtual model was more than 90% accurate in predicting neuronal responses and subsequent behaviors.

Although the current map is based on a single female fruit fly, it offers valuable insights into brain function and structure. The research team plans to expand the project to include male flies and explore additional behaviors, such as singing. However, despite these advancements, researchers acknowledge that much remains to be discovered regarding the chemical and electrical communication between neurons, paving the way for future investigations in the field.






