

Revanth Reddy Concludes Delhi Visit Focused on Key Issues

TPN , Hyderabad: Actor Akkineni Nagarjuna appeared in the Nampally court on Tuesday to testify in a defamation case he filed against Telangana Minister Konda Surekha. The case revolves around Surekha's controversial remarks, alleging that

the minister, accusing her of making false allegations with political motives.

In court, Nagarjuna stated, "Our family, known for its reputation in

BRS leader K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) was responsible for the divorce of Nagarjuna's son, Naga Chaitanya, and actress Samantha.

Nagarjuna condemned the minister's statements, which had sparked outrage in the Telugu film industry. He filed a criminal petition seeking action against

the film industry and social service, has been deeply affected by Minister Konda Surekha's baseless comments. These remarks, broadcasted by television channels and published in newspapers, have caused us significant mental distress and damaged our reputation nationwide."

Following Nagarjuna's testimony, Supriya, a family member, also gave her statement as a witness. She expressed her shock over the minister's claims, adding that their family was deeply hurt by the baseless allegations. The court has adjourned the case to the 10th of this month, when another witness, Venkateswarlu, is expected to testify.

Jagadish Reddy Challenges Bhatti on Musi Riverfront Development and Pollution



TPN , Hyderabad: Former Minister and senior BRS leader G. Jagadish Reddy has challenged Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka to an open debate on the ongoing issues of Musi River pollution and encroachments. He criticized the Congress government for lacking a clear strategy regarding the Musi Riverfront development project and called on the government to present a Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the multi-crore initiative.

Speaking at Telangana Bhavan on Monday, Jagadish Reddy

pointed out that the BRS government had initiated the beautification of the Musi River, with an initial DPR estimating the project cost at Rs. 16,000 crore. He questioned how the current Congress government could claim that the project would now cost Rs. 1.5 lakh crore, especially when there had been no detailed budget discussions in the Cabinet.

"The Congress government cannot even fund key welfare programs like the farm loan waiver. How do they expect to finance Rs. 1.5 lakh crore for

the Musi Riverfront beautification?" Reddy asked.

He accused the Congress of decades of negligence, leading to the pollution of both the Musi River and Hussain Sagar during the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh era. Reddy dared the current government to demolish illegal multi-storied buildings constructed within the Full Tank Level (FTL) of various water bodies around Hyderabad, stating that real beautification would involve preventing pollution and ensuring clean water, not demolishing homes

and uprooting poor families.

Reddy also highlighted former Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao's achievements, including ending the fluorosis issue in Nalgonda and planning to bring water from the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Scheme to Osman Sagar and Himayat Sagar. He criticized the Congress for its demolition of properties worth Rs. 1,000 crore under the guise of beautification, accusing them of mismanaging funds to benefit their allies.



GOVERNMENT WILL SOON ISSUE A MAJOR NOTIFICATION IN

Power Department and Education Sector

- We will fill the vacancies in the electricity department
- We have replaced the promotions that were stuck as poor

TPN, Khammam: In a significant move, Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka announced that the Telangana government will soon issue a major notification to fill all vacant posts in the electricity department. Speaking at a press conference held at the Khammam Collectorate, following a review meeting with officials from Khammam and Warangal districts, Bhatti revealed several key initiatives aimed at improving services in the power and education sectors.

He highlighted that the promotions that had been stalled for the past ten years in the electricity department have now been reinstated. Bhatti appreciated the staff of the Electricity Department for their invaluable service during the recent floods and urged the public to report any educational problems by calling 1912, ensuring that issues would be resolved promptly.

On the occasion of Dussehra, Bhatti Vikramarka announced the Bhumi Puja for the inauguration of an integrated school with state-of-the-art facilities,

including a cinema theater and open-air auditorium, designed for international-level education and sports. He emphasized that this "home-graded" school would set new standards in education across the country.

Regarding SC, ST, and Minority Residential Schools, Bhatti announced the release of Rs. 114 crores to clear pending bills, including smotic charges, mid-day meal bills, and salaries for outsourced employees. He assured that all pending fee reimbursements and scholarships would be released before Dussehra, alongside the immediate provision of transformers and power poles to farmers across the state.

Addressing criticism from opposition leaders like Jagadish Reddy, Bhatti reaffirmed the government's commitment to transparency, democratic decision-making, and development projects, including the beautification of the Musi River. He vowed that no injustice would be done to Musi residents and criticized the previous government's inaction on these issues.

Lotus Hat Trick in Haryana, Disappointed in Kashmir

TPN, New Delhi: Election Results 2024 The BJP has crossed the halfway mark of 46 seats and is ahead in two out of the total 90 constituencies. The alliance of the National Conference (NC) and Congress has won the Jammu and Kashmir assembly polls, which were the first assembly elections since 2014, the first as a Union Territory, and the first after the removal of Article 370, which granted the erstwhile state special status.

In Haryana, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has made history by retaining the state for a record consecutive third term. The BJP has won 48 seats, while the Congress has secured 37.

In Jammu and Kashmir's 90 seats, the

NC and Congress have won 49, the BJP has secured 29, and the PDP has won three. AAP's Mehraj Malik has delivered the Arvind Kejriwal-led party its first-ever electoral victory in Jammu and Kashmir. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, while addressing the BJP cadre at the party headquarters, thanked the people of Haryana "for giving a clear majority to the Bharatiya Janata Party once again." "Lotus bloomed in Haryana," he said.

Congratulating the National Conference for its performance in Jammu and Kashmir, he asserted, "If we look at the vote share percentage, the BJP has emerged as the biggest party in Jammu and Kashmir."



Telangana Government's Key Decision RTC to Rent Buses for Women's Groups

TPN , Telangana : The Telangana government has made significant strides in empowering women since the Congress party took power, focusing on their welfare and participation in various sectors. With initiatives like digital cards recognizing women as homeowners and prioritizing reservations for them, the government is committed to furthering gender equality.

In a recent pivotal move, the government has decided to provide RTC-rented buses to women's associations. This decision aims to enhance mobility and access for women's groups, facilitating their participation in social and economic activities. Minister Prabhakar has already issued orders to prepare a Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the initiative, indicating a proactive approach to ensure its successful rollout. This decision is part of the government's broader strategy to empower women and improve their quality of life in Telangana.

Government to Supply Mother Dairy Ghee and Milk to Temples and Schools



TPN , Telangana : Minister of Roads, Buildings, and Cinematography Komati Reddy Venkat Reddy announced that the government is taking steps to provide Mother Dairy ghee and milk to temples and educational institutions across Telangana. The minister made this announcement during the swearing-in ceremony for the new Chairman Gudipati Madhusudan Reddy at the Mother Dairy office in Hayatnagar on Monday, where he served as the chief guest.

In his address, Minister Venkat Reddy emphasized the government's commitment to revitalize the loss-making Mother Dairy and bring it back into profit. He expressed confidence that with the cooperation of employees and workers, Mother Dairy could thrive and become synonymous with quality products.

Additionally, the minister mentioned that the supply of milk and ghee to temples and government educational institutions would enhance the availability of quality dairy products in these sectors. He also indicated plans to discuss further details regarding Mother Dairy with Chief Minister Revanth Reddy in the near future.

During the event, the minister urged the chairman and members of the governing body to work diligently for the welfare of farmers. The ceremony was attended by several dignitaries, including Ibrahimpatnam MLA Malreddy Rangareddy, Parigi MLA Rammohan Reddy, DCCB Chairman Kumbham Srinivasareddy, Congress leader Muddagoni Rammohan Goud, Mother Dairy MD Krishna, and various governing body members, who all pledged their support for the initiative.

Real Estate Projects in Hyderabad Face Scrutiny for Lake Encroachment

TPN , Hyderabad: Numerous major real estate projects in Hyderabad are under scrutiny for significant encroachments on Full Tank Level (FTL) water bodies. A report by the Telangana Remote Sensing Application Centre (TGRAC) and Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka reveals that over 170 lakes have been encroached upon since 2014, with the Outer Ring Road (ORR) losing approximately 386 acres of land to construction activities.

The findings indicate that several residential and commercial buildings in Hyderabad may have violated regulations concerning encroachment on water bodies, despite obtaining construction permissions.



Among the residential projects identified are Candeur Skyline in the Financial District, the majority of Vertex Viraat in Miyapur, Sumadhura Palais Royale in Puppulaguda, one tower of Cybercity Oriana, the entire

Phoenix 25/Triton, and the entire Vaishnavi Cymbol.

Lake encroachment occurs when property owners build or extend structures onto a lake or its shoreline,

Pooja Magic Breeze in Nekkampur, SMR Vinay Boulder Woods in Bandlaguda Jagir, the entire Vajram Ixora in Gopanpally, and part of Honer Signatis.

The report also highlights significant violations among commercial buildings, including the majority of Phoenix 285 in Puppulaguda, the

entire Phoenix 25/Triton, and the entire Vaishnavi Cymbol. Lake encroachment occurs when property owners build or extend structures onto a lake or its shoreline,

exceeding the lake's boundaries. This often includes clearing vegetation, constructing roads or parks, and developing urban areas. The report notes that various lakes in Kistareddypet, Kuntloor, Shaikpet, Gopanpally, Bachupally, Poppalguda, Peeranchervu, Uppal Bhagat, Rampally, KPHB (Maisamma Chervu), Alwal, and Mamidipally have experienced total encroachment since 2014, primarily due to the rapid expansion of real estate in Hyderabad. Several partly encroached lakes, such as Kithavani Kunta (Narsingi) and Brahmana Kunta (Poppalguda), have also seen substantial encroachments from 2014 to 2023, underscoring the impact of the booming real estate market.

One-Man Judicial Commission Recommended for SC Classification

TPN , Hyderabad: A ministerial sub-committee, chaired by Minister of Irrigation and Civil Supplies Uttam Kumar Reddy, has recommended the establishment of a one-man commission to im-

plement the Scheduled Caste (SC) classification in the state. The meeting, held at Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Telangana Secretariat, included key officials such as Chief Secretary Shanti Kumari and Advocate

General Sudarshan Reddy.

The sub-committee emphasized that the commission's recommendations should be legally binding to avoid any potential legal complications.

In line with the Supreme Court's verdict, the sub-committee also decided to consider the Advocate General's recommendations when appointing the commission. Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy mentioned that a team of officials had previously visited Tamil Nadu and Punjab to study SC clas-

sification. He directed officials to prepare a report detailing employment appointments based on the 2011 census classification of sub-castes. Additionally, the ministerial sub-committee plans to tour districts to gather public opinion on SC classification.

Minister Sitakka underscored the importance of completing the SC classification study in a timely manner, proposing that a socio-economic census of backward classes (BCs) be undertaken on a war footing to facilitate necessary arrangements.

Introduction of a vehicle scrapping policy- Ponna Prabhakar



TPN , Telangana : The Telangana Department of Transport and BC Welfare, led by Minister Ponnamp Prabhakar, is rolling out signif-

icant reforms aimed at enhancing road safety and modernizing transport regulations. The state will integrate with the Sarathi Va-

han Portal, a system already adopted by 28 states, to streamline vehicle registration and licensing processes.

A major reform includes the introduction of a vehicle scrapping policy. Vehicles over 15 years old, and private vehicles older than 8 years, will be scrapped to improve safety and reduce pollution. Telangana is also setting up 32 automatic vehicle testing centers at a cost of ₹8 crores each, in partnership with the central government.

To tackle road accidents, which

claim 1.6 lakh lives annually in India, the state is enforcing stricter regulations, with 8,000 driving licenses already canceled for violations. Additionally, UNICEF is partnering with the state to launch road safety campaigns in schools, and Road Safety Month will be observed next month to raise public awareness.

These reforms apply to all vehicles, including government vehicles and RTC buses. With the appointment of 113 new vehicle inspectors, the state is committed to ensuring safer roads for everyone.

KTR Urges Revanth Reddy Government to Clear Pending Salaries for Contract Workers

TPN , Hyderabad: BRS working president KT Rama Rao has strongly criticized the Congress-led Telangana government for failing to pay salaries to contract and outsourcing workers for the past five to six months. Rama Rao demanded the immediate release of pending salaries to provide relief to the struggling workers and their families.



Expressing concern over the hardships faced by these workers, Rama Rao highlighted the plight of employees from various sectors, including panchayat staff, municipal workers, hospital and hostel employees, and guest lecturers. Many of these workers have been forced into debt, unable to meet their daily needs due to the lack of timely wages.

"Despite promises of timely salary disbursements, countless families reliant on these wages are now drowning in debt and struggling to cover basic expenses," Rama Rao stated. He emphasized that the situation is particularly difficult as the workers face these challenges during the festive season of Dasara, unable to afford even basic goods for the celebrations.

Rama Rao also criticized the government's financial management, noting that despite accumulating Rs 80,000 crore in debt over just 10 months, the administration has failed to pay its workers. He called out the government for its claims of paying salaries on time, which, he pointed out, have not materialized for thousands of employees across the state.

The BRS leader urged the Revanth Reddy government to take immediate action and clear the pending salaries to ease the financial burden on workers and their families

Harish Rao Slams Govt for 10-Month Delay in Fee Reimbursement, Demands Immediate Payment

TPN , Hyderabad: Former Minister and senior BRS leader T. Harish Rao on Tuesday criticized the Congress government for delaying fee reimbursement payments for nearly 10 months, affecting 13 lakh students and several educational institutions across Telangana. Speaking after a meeting with the Telangana Private Degree and PG Colleges Management Association, Harish Rao condemned the delay, accusing the government of jeopardizing students' futures and causing financial strain on colleges.



"Thousands of students are unable to obtain their Transfer Certificates and other important documents, resulting in the loss of an academic year. This negligence is putting immense pressure on students, parents, and college managements," he said.

Rao pointed out that during its nine-year rule, the BRS government had released Rs. 19,000 crore for fee reimbursements, with an annual average of Rs. 2,000 crore, even during the COVID-19 pandemic.

College representatives shared their struggles, explaining that they are unable to pay staff salaries and rents due to the delay in reimbursement. Harish Rao assured them that the BRS would stand by them and demanded the immediate release of pending funds, warning that any further delay could have severe consequences for Telangana's education sector.

KTR Questions Case Against Journalist for Highlighting Farmers' Issues

TPN , Hyderabad: BRS working president KT Rama Rao criticized the State police for filing a case against journalist P. Gowtham Goud, who shared a video of an angry farmer voicing his concerns earlier this year. The video, shot in March, featured a farmer named Mallayya from Mushampalli village in Nalgonda district, discussing the struggles of farmers after the BRS government was defeated in the Assembly elections.

Goud, who uploaded the video on X (formerly Twitter), showcased the farmer's grievances about the lack of water, electricity, and Rythu Bandhu farm investment support. KT Rama Rao questioned the justification for filing the case, asking DGP Jitender to explain what was wrong with the video.

Taking to X, KT Rama Rao stated that he had personally visit-



ed farmer Mallayya to inquire about his situation and sarcastically asked if a case would be filed against him as well for doing so.

KTR's remarks highlight concerns over press freedom and the right to share legitimate issues faced by the farming community in Telangana.

Mandakrishna Madiga Warns Revanth Reddy of Statewide Protests Over SC Classification Issue

TPN , Hyderabad: MRPS Chief Mandakrishna Madiga strongly criticized Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, accusing him of rushing job appointments without addressing the classification of Scheduled Caste (SC) reservations. In a statement to the media on Tuesday, Mandakrishna announced statewide protests on Wednesday against Revanth Reddy's actions. He urged leaders to organize rallies from Ambedkar statues to collector offices in district centers and submit petitions to the collectors.

Mandakrishna Madiga announced that a protest rally would take place from the Ambedkar statue at Tank Bund to Bashir Bagh in Hyderabad. He accused Revanth Reddy of betraying the Madiga community, saying that despite expressing support for them, his actions favor the Mala community, especially during the recent assembly elections where fewer tickets were given to Madiga candidates. Mandakrishna also criticized Revanth



for favoring political allies like Kadiam Srihari and Vivek's family while sidelining Madiga leaders. He demanded that no job appointments be made without SC classification, particularly pointing out the planned issuance

of 11,000 teacher appointment papers. Mandakrishna warned Revanth Reddy not to alienate the Madiga community, hinting that he may reveal further details about political manipulations soon.

MP Raghunandan Rao Criticizes KCR's Absence in Gajwel, Predicts BJP Victory in Telangana



TPN , Medak : Medak MP Raghunandan Rao has made sensational remarks regarding the absence of former Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) in Gajwel, claiming that it has caused significant unrest among the locals. During a recent event in Gajwel, where several individuals joined the BJP from various parties, Rao pointed out that KCR, who once held the title of leader of the opposition, has not fought for the people even for a single day. He asserted that the public has lost faith in the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) and does not want to see the party return to power.

Rao described both the BRS and Congress parties as "puppets," criticizing the frequent migrations of political leaders between parties. He highlighted that not a single MLA elected on a BJP ticket has switched allegiances. Emphasizing the decline of both parties, he remarked that the BRS has been diminished over ten years, while Congress has seen a rapid decline in just ten months.

Addressing recent exit polls that suggest a BJP loss in Haryana, Rao asserted that the reality will differ once the results are announced, indicating a BJP victory. He praised the efforts of BJP President Kishan Reddy in strengthening the party as the main opposition in Jammu and Kashmir. Looking ahead, Rao expressed confidence that when the BJP comes to power in Telangana, the government will mirror the successes seen in Haryana, signaling a renewed commitment to serving the people of the state.

Malkajigiri MP Etala Rajender Pledges to Reopen Old Road Connecting Pochampally and Vijayawada Highway

TPN , Malkajigiri: MP Etala Rajender has assured residents that he will take responsibility for reopening the old road connecting Pochampally-Mansoorabad to the Vijayawada national highway. During an inspection of the closed road in Sri Sainagar Colony with Mansoorabad Corporation Koppula Narsimhareddy, Rajender learned about the significant traffic difficulties caused by the closure.

The road, which has been in existence for nearly a century, was blocked by the Central Plains Agricultural Research Institute (CRIDA), which built a wall across it. Narsimhareddy informed the MP that local residents have been protesting against the road closure for nearly 30 years, but authorities have not responded to their grievances.

In his remarks, Etala Rajender committed to doing everything possible to reopen the Man-



soorabad-Pochampally road after discussions with the central government. He emphasized that reopening this route would alleviate traffic congestion on the Vijayawada National Highway. He also spoke with forest officials, who suggested leaving the old road intact while constructing walls on either side.

The meeting included participation from BJP District President Sama Rangareddy, former councilor Ravinder Reddy, and numerous residents of the colony.

In a related event, MP Etala Rajender attended the 50th anniversary celebration of the P&T Colony, where he underscored the importance of unity among residents to facilitate development. He pledged to take special initiatives to permanently address flooding issues in the colony, located in a low-lying area.

Rajya Sabha Member Anil Kumar Yadav praised the P&T Colony's formation, which includes individuals from various backgrounds, during the golden jubilee celebrations. The event also saw contributions from IFS officer Subhadra Devi, Gaddiannaram Corporation Baddam Premmaheshwar Reddy, and former councilor Bandi Nirmala, among others.

Tati Konda Rajaiah Criticizes Revanth Reddy's Claims on SC Classification

Former Deputy Chief Minister and BRS leader Tati Konda Rajaiah expressed strong disapproval of Congress leader Revanth Reddy's statements regarding the implementation of SC classification in Telangana. Speaking to the media at Telangana Bhavan, Rajaiah referred to Reddy's words as a "boast of Uttara Kumara," accusing him of attempting to deceive the Madigala community.

Rajaiah criticized Reddy for claiming that Telangana would implement SC classification before other states to gain favor from assembly members after the Supreme Court's verdict. He argued that Reddy's political career, which includes positions as ZPTC, MLC, MLA, MP, and CM, has been built on misleading claims.

Rajaiah pointed out that of the three SC MP positions, two were allocated to the Binds community, while ministerial posts were distributed to Malas and Mochis, highlighting a lack of social justice.

BRS Leader RS Praveen Kumar Criticizes Government's Education Policies

In a recent press conference, BRS leader RS Praveen Kumar criticized the Telangana government's education policies, asserting that the Chief Minister (CM) has claimed that the education system has collapsed in the last ten years. He emphasized that the government plans to establish integrated schools in 21 constituencies under the banner of "Young India Integrated Schools."

Praveen Kumar questioned Deputy CM Bhatti's understanding of the gurukula education system, challenging whether either the CM or



Deputy CM has ever visited a gurukul. He pointed out that each gurukul has its own identity and life, serving various social classes. He expressed concern that the

government's push for integrated schools might lead to the closure of existing SC, ST, and BC gurukuls.

Highlighting the government's investment in education, he noted that KCR allocated ₹1 lakh for each student in gurukuls. Praveen Kumar criticized the government's intention to abolish gurukuls and questioned how 2,560 students could be accommodated in a single building, suggesting that the infrastructure is insufficient.

He also accused CM Revanth Reddy and Deputy CM Bhatti of spread-

ing falsehoods, emphasizing that many students from gurukuls are demanding proper faculty and resources. Additionally, he stated that the staff in gurukuls are not receiving adequate salaries and expressed concern over the removal of 2,000 teachers in a single day.

Praveen Kumar called for a comprehensive discussion on the integrated school system, urging the government to focus on the actual needs of students rather than diverting attention from pressing issues.



Tensions Rise Between Congress and BRS Leaders in Telangana

TPN , Telangana: In a heated exchange, Telangana Congress leader Revanth Reddy's remarks about KTR and the BRS government have stirred controversy. Reddy claimed that KTR would "bite your tongue" if false accusations were made against their government's schemes. He accused KTR of promoting a culture of pubs and drugs while asserting that Harish Rao was

competing for the post of Leader of the Opposition.

Reddy emphasized that he was in Delhi to collect GST arrears owed to Telangana and criticized KCR for not participating in development programs in Gajwel. He mocked KTR for his claims of spending ₹1.5 lakh crore on Hyderabad's development, questioning why

funds should be sent to Delhi instead.

Furthermore, Reddy highlighted the establishment of the Musi Corporation and criticized the BRS for failing to beautify the area over the past decade. He dismissed allegations from "pink media" as false and underscored that the Congress party is focused on solving people's problems.



GHMC Demolishes Six Shops for Road Expansion in Mallepally



TPN , Hyderabad: The Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC), in collaboration with Town Planning officials, initiated a major road expansion project in Mallepally, Nampally constituency, on Tuesday, October 8. As part of this effort, six shops near Mallepally X Road were carefully demolished to facilitate the widening of the road.

This road expansion is integral to ongoing efforts to improve traffic flow and upgrade infrastructure in the Mallepally area, ultimately benefiting the local community.

To ensure the safety and security of the area during the demolition process, a substantial police force was deployed nearby. The operation was executed smoothly, with no reports of unrest or resistance from the public.

Feroz Khan Meets Hyderabad Police Commissioner Following Clash with Majid Hussain

TPN , Hyderabad: A clash erupted between Congress leader Feroz Khan and Nampally MLA Majid Hussain, along with their supporters, in Humayun Nagar on Monday, October 7. In response to the incident, Feroz Khan, Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee (TPCC) General Secretary and Nampally candidate, met with Hyderabad Police Commissioner C.V. Anand on Tuesday, October 8, at the Integrated Command and Control Center (ICCC) Building.

After the meeting, Khan reported that he explained the 'attack' on him by MLA Hussain and his followers to the police commissioner. "I submitted details of all the rowdy sheeters who were part of the mob that attacked the Congress workers. I have been assured of tough action against them by the Hyderabad police commissioner," he stated.

Khan denied any association with rowdy elements during his visit to the locality, which was prompted by complaints from residents. He challenged anyone with evidence against him to submit it to the police.

The initial clash occurred when Khan and his supporters visited the Bank Colony, leading to an exchange of blows that resulted in injuries on both sides. Police struggled to control the situation and dispatched additional officers to restore order.

Telangana HC Orders Cancellation of Unused Land Allotments

TPN , Hyderabad:The Telangana High Court has directed the state government to revoke land allocations granted to companies that have not commenced construction or taken steps to establish their businesses. This ruling was issued by a division bench led by Chief Justice Alok Aradhe and Justice J. Sreenivas during a hearing of a public interest litigation (PIL) filed by the Campaign for Housing and Tenural Rights (CHATRI), represented by its secretary, S. Jeevan Kumar.

The court specifically identified several companies, including M/s Indu Techzone Private Limited, M/s Brahmani Infratech Private Limited, M/s Stargaze Properties Private Limited, M/s Anantha Technologies Limited, and M/s JT Holdings Private Limited, as respondents. It mandated the cancellation of their land allotments if they fail to initiate operations within four months.

The PIL asserted that public resources, including land, should serve the community rather than be monopolized by a select few. The petitioners claimed that the Andhra Pradesh Industrial Infrastructure Corporation (APIIC) allocated extensive land

parcels in and around Hyderabad, as well as other areas of undivided Andhra Pradesh, to private firms at minimal costs without conducting public tenders or auctions, which they argued violated constitutional principles.

The petitioners highlighted that APIIC had allotted over 4,156 acres of land from 2001 to 2006 on a nomination basis without any public auction, raising concerns about transparency and the misappropriation of public assets. They referenced a response to a Right to Information (RTI) request confirming that these land allocations occurred without a competitive bidding process.

In defense of the allotments, the state revenue department argued that during that period, there was low demand for industrial land, and these allocations were intended to promote industrial development. However, the court underscored the state's duty as a steward of public resources, emphasizing the necessity for these assets to benefit the public rather than be concentrated in a few hands. It directed the state government to prioritize public interest in future land transactions.

Two Arrested for Digital Fraud Worth Rs 10.61 Crore

TPN , Hyderabad: The Telangana Cyber Security Bureau (TGCSB) has arrested two individuals from Bangalore for their involvement in a digital fraud scheme that resulted in losses of Rs 10.61 crore. The police successfully recovered the stolen funds, including Rs 4.62 crore directly usurped from the victim's account.

The case began when a Hyderabad-based complainant reported on September 9 that he had been contacted by individuals posing as Mumbai police officials. The fraudsters falsely claimed that a bank account had been opened using the victim's Aadhaar and

PAN, implicating him in money laundering activities.

To further deceive the victim, the scammers sent fake letters purportedly from the Directorate of Enforcement and the Income Tax Department, demanding sensitive financial information, including details about properties, deposits, shares, and salary. The accused, identified as Vinay Kumar S. Khadke, 23, and Maruthi G.H., 28, held a joint account under the name of Tinkan Technologies Pvt. Ltd., into which Rs 4.62 crore was transferred from the victim's account.

During the operation, police seized two mobile phones used in the crime. The fraudsters exploited financially vulnerable individuals by offering commissions for access to their bank accounts. They then impersonated law enforcement officials to intimidate the victim into transferring funds. This new method of scamming, termed "digital arrest," highlights the sophisticated tactics employed by fraudsters.

The investigation is ongoing as authorities work to uncover a broader network involved in this fraudulent scheme.

Report Reveals 171 Lakes Encroached in Hyderabad Between 2014 and 2023

TPN , Hyderabad: A recent report by the Planning Department has revealed that 171 water bodies, including local lakes, have been encroached upon in the city over the past decade, coinciding with the formation of Telangana. The report, submitted to Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka, highlights encroachments occurring between 2014 and 2023, notably around the Outer Ring Road (ORR).

increased in another 127 lakes.

The report indicates that Hyderabad and its surrounding areas host a total of 920 tanks and water bodies. When Telangana was established in 2014, it was found that 225 lakes were fully encroached, 196 were partially encroached, and 499 had no encroachments.

In the decade following Telangana's formation, the report reveals alarming statistics: 20 lakes that were previously unencroached are now fully encroached, while 24 lakes that were partly encroached have been entirely lost. Furthermore, encroachments have significantly in-

This report, complete with satellite images and geo-locations of the encroached lakes, comes at a critical time as the state government is leveraging the Hyderabad Disaster Response and Asset Protection Agency (HYDRA) to remove encroachments from city lakes. HYDRA has also been involved in evacuating individuals living in unauthorized homes along the banks of the Musi River.

In the past two weeks, HYDRA and civic authorities have demolished homes and relocated hundreds of people from the Musi River banks, igniting political controversy. Some ruling Congress leaders, such as Danam Nagender, have criticized the government's actions regarding the demolitions. However, both Chief Minister Revanth Reddy and Deputy Chief Minister Vikramarka have defended HYDRA's initiatives, assuring that all evacuees will be provided with 2BHK homes constructed by the state government.

Money Laundering Case

Azharuddin Appears Before ED in Hyderabad

TPN , Hyderabad: Former Indian cricket team captain and Congress leader Mohammed Azharuddin appeared before the Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Tuesday in connection with a money laundering case linked to alleged financial irregularities within the Hyderabad Cricket Association (HCA). Official sources confirmed that the agency will question him and record his statement under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

Azharuddin's role during his tenure as president of the HCA is under scrutiny. The sources indicated that the ED is examining his involvement in the alleged irregularities.



The 61-year-old former Member of Parliament was originally scheduled to appear at the agency's office on Fateh Maidan Road on October 3 but requested a new date, resulting in his summons for October 8. The investigation pertains to alleged financial discrepancies in the HCA, which prompted ED searches in November

There was no immediate response from Azharuddin, who had unsuccessfully contested the assembly elections held last year. Following the registration of the case by the Telangana police, he stated that the allegations against him were "false" and "motivated," describing them as a "stunt" orchestrated by rivals to tarnish his reputation.

The investigation continues as the ED seeks to uncover the extent of the alleged financial misconduct within the association.



Telangana Government Plans to Complete Caste Enumeration Within a Month

TPN , Telangana: The Telangana government is taking steps to fulfill its election promise of conducting a comprehensive caste enumeration. A key meeting, chaired by Transport and BC Welfare Minister Ponnampati Prabhakar, was held at the Secretariat to finalize the schedule for the caste census. BC Commission Chairman Niranjan, Chief Minister's Chief Advisor Vem Narender Reddy, and senior officials from various departments participated in the discussions.

The meeting reviewed caste census procedures implemented in Karnataka, Bihar, and Andhra Pradesh, deciding to adopt the best practices from each state. The government aims to carry out a door-to-door survey to ensure accurate data collection.

With the Supreme Court's positive verdict on SC classification, the caste census report is expected to play a crucial role in finalizing reservations. The meeting also proposed assigning a senior IAS officer to oversee the process, ensuring transparency.

A key meeting with senior ministers is scheduled in the next two days to determine whether the census will be conducted through the General Administration Department (GAD), Panchayati Raj, or Revenue departments. The goal is to complete the caste enumeration within a month.

Key officials, including BC Welfare Department Principal Secretary Burra Venkatesham, attended the meeting.

Army Jawan Injured in Knife Attack Over Loud Music During Bathukamma

TPN , Jogulamba Gadwal: An army jawan suffered serious injuries after being attacked by his neighbor during the Bathukamma festivities in Revulapally village, Dharoor mandal, on Monday night. The incident occurred as women gathered in large numbers to celebrate, dancing to music played through a sound system.

According to reports, Krishna, a local resident, became irritated by the loud music and demanded that the women turn off the sound system. Despite their pleas to continue the celebrations for a few more minutes, Krishna insisted that the festivities stop immediately. In the midst of a heated argument, army jawan Manivardhan intervened, trying to mediate between the women and Krishna.

In a fit of rage, Krishna attacked Manivardhan with a knife, causing severe injuries. The injured jawan was rushed to a local hospital in Gadwal and later transferred to Mahabubnagar for further treatment.

Gadwal Circle Inspector Nageshwar Reddy confirmed that the accused has been taken into custody, and action will be initiated based on complaints from residents.

MLC Kura Raghotham Reddy Demands Release of Pending Bills for Teachers

They must ensure that recipients hold valid drug licenses before supplying any medications. One Year On The Ongoing Crisis Following the Hamas Attacks

Arab nations, while wary of Iran's ambitions, have shown a degree of neutrality in the ongoing conflict, as seen in their recent engagements with Iranian leadership. This reluctance to confront Iran openly complicates the dynamics, especially with the backdrop of missile exchanges between Iran and Israel.

As violence escalates, the situation in Lebanon grows dire, with significant civilian displacement and calls for humanitarian relief. International leaders have urged for a ceasefire to facilitate diplomatic solutions, yet the cycle of retaliation continues.

India, maintaining ties with both Iran and Israel, emphasizes dialogue and restraint amid the unfolding crisis. The potential for broader conflict raises concerns for regional stability and economic security, particularly for India, which has deep interests in the region.

As the situation evolves, the absence of effective multilateral solutions threatens to plunge the region further into chaos. Without decisive actions towards de-escalation and dialogue, the prospects for peace remain bleak.

Envy, often viewed negatively, is paradoxically a significant driver of economic growth. It fuels consumer motivation and spending, as seen with the iPhone since its debut in 2007. The sleek design of the iPhone has transformed it into a status symbol, akin to the once-coveted Onida television, but now amplified by social media.

The iPhone's role transcends utility; it serves as a platform for cultivating influence. As Thomas Elsaesser noted in 2005, the telecommunications revolution pitted everyday usefulness against the allure of simulated experiences. Today, simulation has triumphed, with smartphones becoming venues for curated identities and aspirations.

Discussions about social media often focus on the vulnerable, but it's crucial to recognize

how affluent adults contribute to a culture of envy. Posing with luxury items, even if empty, caters to peers rather than addressing the realities of the marginalized. Kiran V Bhatia highlights how digital glamour offers slum children fleeting glimpses of aspirational lifestyles, yet fails to translate into real upward mobility. They become collateral damage in a spectacle aimed at generating envy among the privileged.

Curation emerges as a critical concept, revealing how individuals create curated identities to signal status. However, this curation can lead to "iSlavery," as scholars like Jack Linchuan Qiu argue that smartphones have created new forms of enslavement rather than freedom. Adults, despite seeming empowered, become trapped in a cycle of digital validation and envy-driven consumption.

This cultural imperialism reflects a profound exploitation of human consciousness, leading ultimately to anomie—a sense of emptiness in the quest for authentic connection and identity. The smartphone era demands a reevaluation of our values, urging a shift from envy to genuine engagement.

Smaller parties and independents, some aligned with the BJP, are also making headway, leading in nine seats. BJP leaders have expressed confidence that their tally will allow them to form the government, aided by five MLAs nominated by the Governor.

National Conference and Congress Win Historic J&K Election

The National Conference (NC) and Congress secured a significant victory in the Jammu and Kashmir elections, marking the first such polls in a decade and defying predictions of a hung Assembly. Together, the alliance claimed 49 out of 90 elected seats, with five additional seats set to be nominated by Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha under a contentious new rule.



The NC emerged as the dominant force, winning 42 seats, while Congress managed a mere six. The NC's success was particularly strong in the Kashmir region, where it claimed the majority of its seats. The BJP, which has never governed J&K independently, finished with 29 seats—four more than in 2014 but still below expectations, primarily drawing support from the Jammu region.

Former Chief Minister Mehbooba Mufti's People's Democratic Party (PDP), which had allied with the BJP in the past, was expected to play a crucial role this election.

Exit polls suggested the PDP could secure between four and 12 seats, potentially tipping the balance in favor of the Congress-NC alliance. However, the PDP only managed to win three seats, losing significantly compared to its previous performance.

In a notable development, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) secured its first seat in J&K, winning in Doda. The Jammu and Kashmir People's Conference also saw success, with Sajjad Lone retaining his seat. Independent candidates continued to perform well, claiming seven seats.

Can't Accept Verdict Congress Raises Doubts Over Haryana Counting

The Congress party expressed shock and disbelief over the unexpected election results in Haryana, where the BJP appears poised to secure a historic third consecutive term. The party's initial optimism turned to dismay as early leads for Congress faded, prompting senior leader Jai Ram Ramesh to voice serious concerns about the integrity of the counting process.

In a letter to the Election Commission, Congress highlighted an "unexplained slowdown" in result updates, which Ramesh claimed could fuel misinformation and undermine public trust in the electoral process. The Election Commission dismissed these allegations, assuring that results were being updated regularly across constituencies.

At a press conference, Ramesh stated, "The results in Haryana are totally unexpected, completely surprising and counter-intuitive. It goes against the reality and what the people of Haryana were looking for—change." He described the outcome as a "victory for manipulation" and vowed that the chapter on Haryana was not closed, promising to gather evidence regarding irregularities in the counting process.

Ramesh also noted serious complaints about the functioning of electronic voting machines (EVMs) in several districts, raising doubts about the overall cred-



ibility of the election. He claimed that at least 12-14 seats were under scrutiny due to alleged discrepancies, emphasizing the need for the party to present its findings to the Election Commission.

Pawan Khera, another senior Congress leader, echoed Ramesh's concerns, citing consistent reports of EVM issues, particularly in districts like Hisar and Mahendragarh. He questioned the reliability of machines reporting unusual battery statuses, linking it to perceived manipulation.

Never be over confident Kejriwal on Haryana poll results

As early trends indicate a strong lead for the BJP in Haryana, Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) convener Arvind Kejriwal acknowledged a critical lesson from the election results: never be overconfident. The BJP is projected to secure victory in approximately 50 of the 90 assembly seats, reinforcing Kejriwal's point during a gathering of AAP municipal councillors.



"Let us see what the results are in Haryana. The biggest lesson is that one should never be overconfident in elections," Kejriwal stated, emphasizing the importance of respecting every electoral contest. He urged party members to remember that each election, and indeed each seat, is challenging and should be approached with seriousness.

The AAP faced significant hurdles in its electoral strategy, failing to forge a pre-poll alliance with the Congress due to disagreements over seat-sharing. Consequently, the party contested 89 of the 90 seats independently, trailing behind both the BJP and Congress in nearly all constituencies.

During the campaign, Kejriwal had confidently declared that no government could be formed in Haryana without AAP's involvement. However, the current results suggest otherwise, with AAP candidates struggling to make an impact.

In response to the situation, Kejriwal turned his focus to the upcoming Delhi Assembly elections, scheduled for February. He called upon AAP councillors to prioritize their local responsibilities, particularly in ensuring efficient garbage collection and disposal within their wards. "You will have the most important role in this election. If you ensure proper garbage management, we will secure victory," he asserted, highlighting how foundational tasks can influence voter sentiment.

Haryana Chief Minister Saini Credits Modi for BJP's Hat-Trick

Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini attributed the BJP's hat-trick victory in the state to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership, just six months after assuming office. Speaking to reporters as the counting process neared its conclusion, Saini expressed gratitude to the voters, emphasizing that this win represents a triumph for the farmers, women, and youth of Haryana.



"I thank the 2.8 crore residents of Haryana for their faith in Prime Minister Modi's policies. This victory is a testament to the support of our farmers, the underprivileged, women, and young people. They voted for the tangible progress brought by PM Modi," stated

the 54-year-old BJP leader. Saini won the Ladwa seat by over 16,000 votes, reflecting his confidence that the people would "bless" the party for its continuous efforts.

Saini's appointment as chief minister earlier this year was a surprise move

by the BJP after the resignation of his predecessor, Manohar Lal Khattar, due to coalition tensions. Sources indicate that the BJP plans to retain Saini for another term in light of this election success.

As per the latest counts, the BJP leads in 48 of the 90 assembly seats, with Congress trailing behind at 37. The Indian National Lok Dal (INLD) appears set to win two seats, while Independents are expected to secure three.

Earlier in the day, Congress filed a complaint regarding an "unexplained slowdown" in result updates, which the Election Commission dismissed, assuring that updates were being processed regularly.

CPM's Tarigami Wins J&K Seat

A key development in the Jammu and Kashmir Assembly elections is the resurgence of the National Conference and the Abdullah family. However, an equally significant outcome is the success of MY Tarigami, a prominent Communist leader, in Kulgam. Tarigami defeated a candidate backed by the hardline Jamaat-e-Islami, despite the organization's attempts to polarize the electorate along religious lines.



According to Election Commission data, Tarigami leads by nearly 8,000 votes against Jamaat-backed Sayar Ahmed Reshi. Prior to the election in this Muslim-majority constituency, the Jamaat candidate claimed that his loss would signify the "defeat of Islam." The election results, however, showed that this strategy of polarization failed.

In an interview with NDTV as results were confirmed, Tarigami, a four-time MLA, expressed gratitude to the people of Kulgam for standing up for their rights and resisting divisive tactics. "I salute the people of Kulgam. They fought for Kulgam, for Kashmir, for the rights of the people of

Kashmir, and defeated those who became collaborators of the government," he stated.

The Jamaat-e-Islami, previously a significant player in militancy and separatism during the 1990s, has faced challenges since its ban in 2019. Its attempts to regain influence through electoral politics have not succeeded, as evidenced by Tarigami's win. "The people have rejected the BJP and supported the secular alliance of the National Conference, Congress, and CPM," Tarigami concluded.

Congress celebrates majority in J-K

As counting of votes continues, early trends reveal that the Congress has crossed the critical threshold of 46 seats in Jammu and Kashmir, while the BJP has secured a commanding lead in Haryana.

In Haryana, the BJP is currently ahead on 48 seats, surpassing the halfway mark, while the Congress trails with 37 seats. The Indian National Lok Dal (INLD) is showing strength with 2 seats, and other parties have claimed 3.

In Jammu and Kashmir, the Congress-National Conference alliance is leading in 49 seats, while the BJP and the PDP are ahead in 29 and 3 seats, respectively. The alliance's success positions Omar Abdullah as a likely candidate for chief minister, whereas the BJP has yet to announce its CM nominee. Sources suggest that Nayab Singh Saini may continue as chief minister in the BJP's third term.



The counting process began at 8 AM, starting with postal ballots, followed by EVM votes half an hour later. These early trends are preliminary, and final results may vary significantly as counting progresses.

October 7 Attack Would Never Have Happened If I Was President: Trump

At a campaign event held at his Trump National Doral Golf Club in Florida, Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump emphasized the importance of remembering the October 7, 2023, attacks on Israel by Hamas militants. Speaking to a crowd of a few hundred attendees, Trump described the day as a "nightmare" and called for Americans to "never forget" the tragic events that unfolded.



During his remarks, Trump asserted that the attacks would not have occurred had he been in office, reflecting a recurring theme in his campaign rhetoric. He positioned himself as a strong leader capable of preventing such incidents, appealing to voters' concerns about national security and international relations.

The October 7 attacks resulted in significant loss of life and escalated tensions in the Middle East, prompting international condemnation and a military response from Israel. Trump used the anniversary to draw attention to his foreign policy record, contrasting it with the current administration's approach. He claimed that his presidency fostered a safer environment for both the United States and its allies, arguing that his policies would have deterred such violence.

Critics have pointed out that Trump's

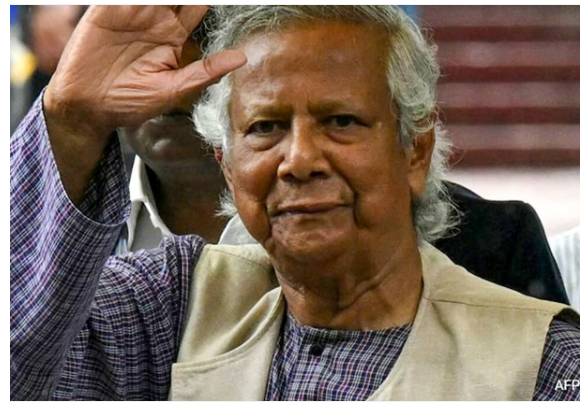

Under Hasina's 15-year rule, the country faced severe human rights abuses, including mass detentions and extrajudicial killings of political opponents. A preliminary United Nations

report indicated that over 600 people died in the weeks leading up to her removal, suggesting that this figure may be an underestimate. Hasina's administration was also criticized for undermining the judiciary and conducting unfair elections, which eroded democratic checks on power.

Yunus described the public administration system he inherited as "completely broken down," calling for a comprehensive overhaul to prevent a return to autocratic rule. "Reforms mean we will not allow a repetition

He also addressed concerns about press freedom, as at least 25 journalists perceived as supporters of Hasina's government have been arrested for alleged violence against protesters. Reporters Without Borders condemned these arrests as "systematic judicial harassment." However, Yunus expressed his commitment to media freedom, stating, "Write as you please. Criticise. Unless you write, how will we know what is happening or not happening?"

Kamala Harris Reveals Glock Ownership Amid Election Scrutiny

In a recent interview aired on CBS's 60 Minutes, Democratic presidential candidate Kamala Harris disclosed that she owns a Glock semi-automatic pistol and confirmed that she has fired it at a shooting range. This revelation follows her earlier statement to Oprah Winfrey, where she expressed her status as a gun owner and asserted that she would shoot anyone who attempted to break into her home.



"I have a Glock, and I've had it for quite some time," Harris stated, highlighting her background in law enforcement as a former prosecutor and California attorney general. When asked by interviewer Bill Whitaker if she had ever fired the Glock, Harris responded with a laugh, "Of course I have. At a shooting range. Yes, of course, I have."

Glock, the Austrian manufacturer of the firearm, is known for producing one of America's best-selling handguns, popular among police and

with a notable presence in films and hip-hop culture. Until now, Harris had seldom discussed her gun ownership, aligning with her party's focus on reducing access to firearms in a nation grappling with gun violence and mass shootings.

As the election tightens against Republican challenger Donald Trump, the 59-year-old Democrat has begun to emphasize her gun-owning

credentials. Trump has repeatedly accused Harris of wanting to confiscate Americans' firearms, suggesting her stance violates the Second Amendment. During their televised debate last month, he reiterated these claims.

Harris vehemently denied Trump's allegations, asserting that both she and her running mate, Tim Walz, are gun owners. "I'm a gun owner," she affirmed to Winfrey, adding with a chuckle, "If someone breaks into my house, they're getting shot."

This gun ownership revelation was one of several significant points in the interview, where Harris adeptly addressed challenging questions on issues such as immigration and the economy. Notably, Trump recently opted out of a planned 60 Minutes interview, breaking a long-standing tradition for presidential candidates to participate in the program before an election.

Regional Tensions Escalate as Israel Strikes Gaza and Lebanon



A barrage of rockets was fired at Israel from both Gaza and Lebanon on Tuesday, marking a year since the outbreak of war with Hamas, which began on October 7. The ongoing conflict continues to threaten broader regional instability.

Hezbollah, the Iranian-backed Lebanese militant group, claimed responsibility for targeting an Israeli military intelligence base near Tel Aviv with a series of rocket attacks. Reports indicate that they also struck a military base south of Haifa and launched missiles toward Tiberias, causing sirens to sound across the region, although Israeli authorities reported no casualties.

In retaliation, Israeli warplanes conducted extensive airstrikes in Lebanon, particularly in the Beqaa Valley and Beirut, targeting over 120 sites associated with Hezbollah, including launchers and command centers. The Israeli military also expanded its ground operations in northern Gaza, where they reported casualties among Israeli troops during confrontations with Hamas and Islamic Jihad fighters.

On the ground, the humanitarian crisis in Gaza remains dire, with over 41,000 fatalities reported, the majority of whom are civilians. As Israeli operations intensify, nearly the entire population of Gaza—about 2.3 million people—has been displaced, living in severe conditions in refugee camps.

In Israel, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu emphasized the nation's commitment to continue fighting its enemies. "As long as our hostages are in Gaza, we will continue to fight," he stated, underscoring Israel's resolve amid ongoing conflict.

Despite international calls for a ceasefire, including recent pleas from French Foreign Minister Jean-Noël Barrot, attempts to de-escalate the situation have repeatedly failed. Barrot reiterated France's unwavering commitment to Israel's security while also acknowledging that military force alone cannot ensure lasting peace.

As tensions mount and the humanitarian situation worsens, the prospect of a ceasefire remains uncertain, with both sides entrenched in their positions.

Hezbollah Chief Nasrallah's Successor Likely Killed Says Israeli Minister

Israeli Defense Minister Yoav Gallant announced on Tuesday that it seems the potential replacement for the late Hezbollah leader Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah has been eliminated. Hashem Safieddine, a senior official within Hezbollah, had been widely regarded as the likely successor to Nasrallah, who has led the group for over two decades.

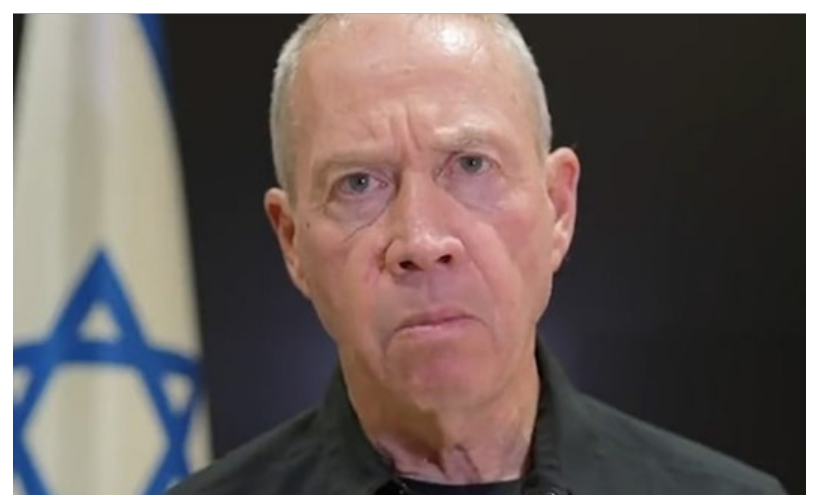
Gallant's comments suggest a significant

Paytm stock rises 16%, marking best single-day gain since February

Shares of Paytm surged by up to 15.76% on Tuesday, marking its largest single-day gain since February 8, 2023. After experiencing three consecutive days of losses, the stock rebounded on October 8, signaling a potential recovery phase following recent profit-taking. In the past week, Paytm's stock has climbed 4.30%, a welcome turnaround after hitting an all-time low of ₹310 earlier this year due to restrictions imposed by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on its Payments Bank.



The reasons behind the stock's rally remain uncertain, but it suggests a recovery from a challenging period. Paytm's share price has been significantly impacted since the RBI's January restrictions, which barred the company from accepting new deposits and processing credit transactions.

Currently, the stock's Relative Strength Index (RSI) stands at 61, indicating it is approaching "overbought" territory, with levels above 70 typically suggesting overvaluation. Despite the recent gains, Paytm's shares are still 66% lower than their IPO price of ₹2,150, which debuted on the stock exchanges in 2021.

Bank Deposit Growth Hits Two-Month High Says RBI



In September, banks in India experienced a notable surge in deposit growth, reaching a more than two-month high. According to data from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), the deposit growth rate stood at 11.34% as

of September 20, 2024, up from 10.96% recorded on September 6. This increase in deposit growth can be attributed to various innovative schemes and competitive efforts by banks to attract liabilities through higher inter-

est rates.

Earlier in the year, banks witnessed even more robust deposit growth, peaking at 12.55% as of June 28, 2024. However, from July 12 to September 6, the growth rate fluctuated between 10.64% and 11.09%, indicating a more volatile period prior to the recent uptick.

In contrast to the deposit growth, credit growth has remained stable at around 13% throughout the same period. This stability suggests that while banks are successfully attracting deposits, they are also managing their lending activities effectively.

Adani Green units plan to raise up to \$1 billion in dollar bonds

Subsidiaries of India's Adani Green Energy are set to raise up to \$1 billion through the issuance of U.S. dollar-denominated bonds, according to two merchant bankers involved in the transaction. The bond issuance is expected to feature a maturity period of 20 years and will occur in one or more tranches, with plans to begin as early as this month.



The decision to tap the bond market comes as the companies assess investor sentiment through a series of upcoming roadshows. One of the bankers, who requested anonymity due to the sensitivity of the matter, indicated that the firms are closely monitoring market conditions before making a definitive move.

The bond market has been an attractive option for companies seeking to raise capital, especially amid a growing global focus on green energy investments. Adani Green Energy's planned bond issuance reflects this trend, as more investors are looking to support environmentally sustainable projects.

SEBI Permits Stockbrokers to Trade Government Securities

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has announced that stockbrokers will now be permitted to trade in government securities (G-Secs) through the Reserve Bank of India's negotiated dealing system-order matching (NDS-OM). This system, introduced in 2005, facilitates secondary market trading of G-Secs and is maintained by the Clearing Corporation of India (CCIL).



SEBI's proposal, made on October 4, aims to enhance retail participation in G-Sec trading by allowing brokers to offer these services as a Separate Business Unit (SBU). This initiative is designed to create an additional revenue stream for brokers, enabling them to diversify their offerings and attract retail clients who typically utilize their services

Experts highlight that this move is critical for boosting retail involvement in G-Secs, which are considered a solid alternative to fixed deposits. Shruti Jain, Chief Security Officer at Arihant Capital, noted that the NDS-OM system's adoption is expected to significantly increase retail participation, as brokers can now directly buy and sell G-Secs

without relying on third parties like mutual funds.

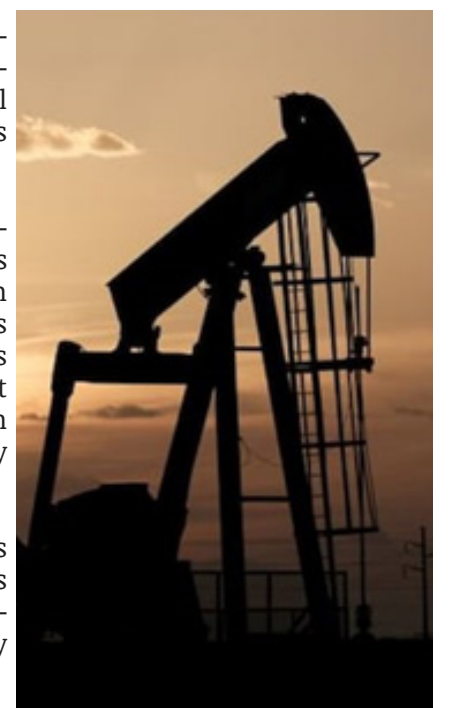
Currently, the NDS-OM system is open to banks, primary dealers, insurance companies, and mutual funds. With the new changes, stockbrokers can engage directly in government securities transactions, enhancing market access for retail investors.

India Confident in Oil Supply Stability Amid West Asia Tensions

Energy experts assert that the global oil market has sufficient supply to meet China's crude oil demands, even in the event of an Israeli attack on Iran's oil infrastructure. China, as the largest oil importer, relies heavily on Iran, purchasing over 90 percent of its oil exports.

Hitesh Jain, an analyst at Yes Securities, explained that the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) possesses enough spare capacity to mitigate any disruptions resulting from such an attack. "If Israel attacks Iran's oil infrastructure, there is enough spare capacity within OPEC. For instance, Saudi Arabia has a production capacity of 12 to 12.5 million barrels per day (bpd) but currently produces about 9 million bpd. OPEC has around 5 million bpd of spare capacity, which can adequately compensate for any adverse situations that may arise from the attack," Jain noted.

As tensions escalate in the Middle East, fears of an attack on Iran's oil facilities have become more pronounced, raising concerns about potential disruptions in the global oil market. Such disruptions could have significant implications for oil prices and supply chains, particularly given the current geopolitical climate.
