KTR on Formula E Probe: I'm Ready to Face Jail

TPN , Hyderabad : Former Minister K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) made bold statements during a meeting at Telangana Bhavan, addressing the ongoing controversy related to the Formula E car race held during the BRS government's tenure.

Reports suggest that the Municipal and Urban Development Corporation has requested an Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) investigation into alleged irregularities, including the premature release of foreign currency payments without proper approval. A potential case against KTR has also been speculated, with the state government reportedly seeking the governor's consent for an FIR. Speaking on the matter, KTR asserted, "I have not received any formal notice from the ACB; only media reports have surfaced. I take full responsibility for authoriz-

ing the decisions and funding for the Formula E race, which boosted Hyderabad's brand value and brought investments worth thousands of crores, yielding Rs. 700 crores for the state." He defended his actions, citing the use of HANDA (Hyderabad Agency for New Development and Activities) funds that did not require cabinet approval.

Emphasizing his readiness for any legal consequences, KTR said, "If the ACB files a case, I am prepared to face it and go to jail. I will practice yoga and come out fitter. Revanth Reddy may take satisfaction in my arrest, but I have no fear."

KTR also lashed out at CM Revanth Reddy, accusing him of indulging in "satanic pleasure" by targeting BRS for political gains and un-

dermining Hyderabad's reputation. He challenged Reddy to initiate similar investigations against influential figures like Mega Krishna Reddy, linked to the Sunkishala wall collapse that incurred an Rs. 80 crore loss. "Blacklist his company and send the ACB if you dare," KTR challenged, adding that accountability should extend to all, including Reddy himself.

The former minister highlighted the investments Formula E brought and compared it to global sporting events, pointing out the extravagant costs of hosting the Olympics. "Rio 2016 cost Rs. 8 lakh crores, and Tokyo 2020 cost Rs. 2.9 lakh crores. This year, Hyderabad could host the Olympics. Can you even handle a Rs. 50 crore event?" KTR questioned.

The minister further criticized KTR for what he called "dramas" about his upcoming padayatra. He suggested redistributing funds to village panchayats, highlighting alleged misappropriations by BRS leaders. Accusing BRS of systemic corruption, Ponguleti stated that their misdeeds were becoming increasingly apparent to the public. He alleged widespread land grabbing under the guise of the Dharani scheme and promised that a new revenue law would be introduced soon to safeguard the people's rights. With Ponguleti's recent assertion about an upcoming explosive revelation, following a police raid at KTR's brother-in-law's residence, political tensions have heightened, making his statements the focal point of widespread speculation.

Detour in Bhudan Land Case: RDO Venkatachari Faces ED Inquiry

TPN , Rangareddy : The ongoing investigation into the alienation of 42 acres of Bhudan land in Nagaram, Rangareddy district, has taken a significant turn. Officials connected to the case have been appearing for questioning by the Enforcement Directorate (ED), with RDO Venkatachari being the latest to comply.



The ED's comprehensive probe into the case initially spotlighted IAS officer Amoy Kumar, prompting further summons based on evidence gathered. Recent information provided by MMAR Jyoti has propelled the investigation forward. On Thursday, RDO Venkatachari appeared before the ED, armed

with insights from former Collector Amoy Kumar and MMAR Jyoti. The case centers on 42 acres registered to a woman named Qadarunni Shah, allegedly facilitated by officials, including Amoy Kumar, Tahsildar Jyoti,

and RDO Venkatachari. It is suspected that substantial bribes were exchanged to facilitate the transfer, with ED probing financial transactions involved.

The disputed land, part of a 102-acre tract in Nagaram, includes 50 acres attributed to the Bhudan Board, originally donated by Haji Khan after inheriting it from his father, Jabardasta Khan. The registration in the name of Khadurunisha, who claimed heirship less than three years ago, raised suspicions as officials allegedly expedited the process. ED's ongoing investigation aims to uncover any political involvement in the land transfer.

ED Issues Notices to Former Minister CH Mallareddy

Allegations of illegal sale of PG seats by medical colleges

TPN , Hyderabad : The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has issued notices to former Telangana minister CH Mallareddy in connection

with the alleged illegal sale of postgraduate (PG) medical seats. The ED has directed Mallareddy to appear for a hearing today. Surender Reddy, the Administrative Officer of Mallareddy Medical College, has already attended and provided an explanation to the agency.

The ED's investigation follows complaints about the sale of PG seats across several medical colleges in Telangana. In June last year, the ED conducted searches at Mallareddy's residence, medical college, and offices, as well as at 12 other pri-

vate medical institutions. During these raids, officials seized critical documents, hard disks, and pen drives.

The ED's findings indicate that 45 PG seats in 10 private medical colleges were blocked and sold. Notices have been issued to Mallareddy and other colleges involved, requiring them to provide clarifications on the matter.

The investigation underscores the ED's focus on ensuring accountability and transparency in the state's medical education sector.

HC Criticizes Assembly Secretary's Role in MLA Disqualification Case

TPN , Hyderabad : The Chief Justice Bench of the Telangana High Court conducted a crucial hearing on the disqualification petitions involving MLAs who switched parties. The hearing addressed a petition filed by the Assembly Secretary regarding the disqualification process. During the session, Advocate Mayur Reddy represented Kadiam Srihari, while Advocate Gandra Mohan Rao argued on behalf of the BRS MLAs. The bench observed that the Assembly Secretary lacks the authority to file such petitions, emphasizing that disqualification matters should be placed before the Speaker for review. The single judge remarked that it is inappropriate for the Assembly Secretary to bypass the Speaker's directive and decide not to present the petitions. The judge stressed that as a government employee, the Assembly Secretary is obligated to follow court orders, warning that enjoying administrative power while neglecting responsibilities is unacceptable. Advocate Gandra Mohan Rao contended that the appeals filed by the Assembly Secretary are not maintainable and should be dismissed. He also noted that one MLA, who defected, later contested as an MP, suggesting the complexity of the case. The court decided to adjourn the hearing until tomorrow after considering the arguments presented.

This case stems from a petition filed in the Telangana High Court seeking the disqualification of MLAs who won under the BRS ticket and later joined Congress. Kukatpally MLA KP Vivekanand Goud and Huzurabad legislator Padi Kaushik Reddy recently filed petitions, urging the court to take action since the Speaker's office had not responded to their requests.

Deputy CM Bhatti Vikramarka Inaugurates Civil Services Coaching Centre in Ashok Nagar

TPN , HYDERABAD : Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka Malu inaugurated a Civil Services Coaching Centre in Ashok Nagar, emphasizing the government's commitment to filling two lakh vacant posts in Telangana. He noted that 50,000 positions have already been filled, and the Congress government has begun releasing an annual job calendar, a first in the country, with competitive exam schedules disclosed in advance.

Highlighting support for UPSC aspirants, Mr. Bhatti announced a Rs 1 lakh incentive for candidates from Telangana who qualify for the UPSC Mains exam. Those who pass the Mains and are shortlisted for interviews will receive an additional Rs 1 lakh. These measures aim to assist financially disadvantaged candidates with study materials and training.



Mr. Bhatti pointed out that increasing the number of civil service candidates from Telangana would greatly benefit the state through better representation in policy design and welfare schemes. He praised Telugu-speaking officers Mohan Rao and Aruna for helping establish the coaching centre. The Deputy CM also stressed the importance of establishing more coaching centres to ensure more candidates from Telangana succeed in the Civil Services exams.

Progress on Yadagirigutta Temple's Golden Gopuram Reviewed by Minister Konda Surekha

TPN , Hyderabad : Minister for Forests, Environment, and Devadaya Charities, Konda Surekha, has highlighted that Telangana is home to the tallest Golden Gopuram in the country, located at the Sri Lakshminarasimha Swamy Temple in Yadagirigutta. During a recent review meeting, she provided updates on the development works at the temple, led by the Yadagirigutta Temple Development Authority (YTDA), ahead of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's scheduled visit to the temple tomorrow. Minister Surekha reported that 1,600 square feet of the 10,000 square feet planned for gold plating on the Vimana Gopuram has been completed. She confirmed that the gold plating work will begin on November 15, 2024. A total of 60 kg of gold will be used for the plating, with an estimated cost of Rs. 8 crores. The minister set a deadline for completion by March 1, 2025, to coincide with the temple's Brahmotsavam, after which the grand consecration ceremony (Maha Kumbhabhishekam) will be held, led by CM Revanth Reddy.

In the meeting, Minister Surekha also inquired about the compensation for families displaced due to the temple's expansion and reviewed the progress of other development projects. YTDA Vice Chairman Kishan Rao presented the status of land acquisition, budget allocation, and pending works. The minister stressed the importance of following guidelines for donor-funded projects and directed YTDA officials to present detailed updates for the review by CM Revanth Reddy.

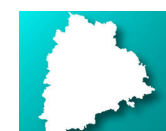
Minister Ponnam Prabhakar Lays Foundation Stones for Development Works in Husnabad



TPN , Siddipet : Minister Ponnam Prabhakar laid the foundation stones for several key development projects in Husnabad Municipality, with each of the town's 20 municipal wards allocated Rs. 50 lakhs for improvements. A total of Rs. 2 crore has been earmarked for the development of wards 3, 4, 5, and 10. Minister Prabhakar was joined by Siddipet District Collector Manu Chaudhary, Municipal Chairperson Akula Rajitha Venkanna, Vice Chairman Aileni Anitha, and other local officials at the event. The foundation works will include the construction of community

reading rooms, allocated at Rs. 45 lakhs each, and the development of four key squares in Husnabad: Gandhi, Ambedkar, Nagaram, and Karimnagar. In addition, an 18-crore rupee tender is ready for the development of Ellamma Cheruvu Bund. The Minister also confirmed that plans to establish a drainage system to prevent floodwater from entering the town are underway, and improvements to the main roads will be made. Minister Prabhakar highlighted the government's commitment to boosting infrastructure in Husnabad, with ongoing projects including a 150-bed hospital, the de-

velopment of tourism sites like Sarvai Papanna Goud and Ocean Gandhi, and the establishment of an industrial corridor. Additionally, 3,500 Indiramma houses have been sanctioned, with the Bhumi Puja for these projects scheduled soon. Prabhakar assured the public that the government will fulfill all promises, including increased ration shops and improved facilities. He emphasized the importance of the house-to-house survey for understanding and addressing social issues, while also assuring that any problems related to Husnabad would be resolved.



Minister Sridhar Babu's Key Instructions on Grain Purchases in Bhupalapally



TPN , Bhupalapally: Minister of State for IT and Industries, Duddilla Sridhar Babu, emphasized the importance of purchasing grains at the support price without any issues for farmers during his visit to Bhupalapally district on Wednesday. Alongside District Collector Rahul Sharma, the

Minister inaugurated several initiatives. Sridhar Babu stressed that there should be no imports of cotton from other countries, as the nation has sufficient reserves. He called for an extensive awareness campaign to educate farmers about the types of grains eligible for fine grain classification.

The Minister instructed officials to ensure smooth operations at grain purchase centers, with specific attention to the differences between "doddu" and "sanna" types of grains. He highlighted that rice millers should not impose unnecessary cuts in the name of talu. Additionally, Sridhar Babu emphasized that all eligible farmers should receive the Rs 500 bonus announced for small grains.

To curb the entry of grains from other states, the Minister called for strict monitoring at district borders and advised the implementation of stringent measures.

Kishan Reddy Attacks Congress on Financial Crisis in Telangana, Pledges BJP's Resolve



TPN , Telangana : Union Minister Kishan Reddy has criticized Congress-ruled states, labeling them financially bankrupt and claiming that within just 11 months of Congress rule in Telangana, the opposition is already growing among the public. Speaking at an organizational election meeting in Secunderabad, Reddy emphasized that the BJP is committed to addressing "anti-people" policies of the Congress government.

On the Musi river cleanup project, Reddy supported efforts to bring water from the Krishna and Godavari rivers to the Musi but opposed demolitions in the Musi catchment area, stressing the impact on real estate. He expressed willingness to stay in the area to experience the conditions firsthand, while also supporting Revanth Reddy's visit to the Musi catchment.

Reddy accused the Telangana government of failing to fulfill promises, particularly with regard to grain procurement, and said the situation for Telangana's people has worsened under Congress rule. He emphasized the importance of strengthening the BJP's organizational structure while combating the state's government on key issues.

Reddy clarified his stance on the caste census, stating he has no objection to it. He also pushed for the implementation of 42 percent reservation for BCs in local body elections. Furthermore, Reddy revealed that BJP's MLC candidates would soon be announced based on winnability, and pledged to visit grain purchasing centers and address flyover issues with Chief Minister Revanth Reddy.

BJP MP Laxman Criticizes Congress' Caste Census Proposal as 'Cheating'

Ponnala Lakshmaiah Criticizes Congress' Caste Census Rhetoric

TPN , Hyderabad: Senior BRS leader and former minister Ponnala Lakshmaiah has sharply criticized the Congress party over its stance on the caste census, particularly pointing out the contradiction between the party's rhetoric and its internal structure. Lakshmaiah took aim at Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's vocal support for a caste census, noting the stark imbalance in the Congress Working Committee (CWC). He pointed out that out of 39 members, only 3 are from the OBC community, highlighting the disparity between the party's calls for social justice and its own lack of representation for marginalized groups.



Taking to social media, Lakshmaiah remarked sarcastically, "With only 3 OBCs out of 39 in the CWC, the Congress's caste census rhetoric is more preaching and less practice." He further emphasized that before advocating for policies like the caste census, Congress should first focus on improving its own internal representation of marginalized communities, ensuring that its leadership reflects the diversity it promotes. Lakshmaiah's comments come amid ongoing political discourse surrounding the caste census and the need for more inclusive policies within India's political parties.

Telangana Government to Launch Phase II of Integrated Schools on November 14

TPN , Hyderabad : Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy announced the launch of Phase II of the integrated schools initiative on November 14, coinciding with Children's Day. The project aims to establish schools across the state on 20-25 acres in each assembly constituency. The second phase will involve 15,000 students, marking a significant milestone in the government's commitment to improving education.

During the announcement, the Chief Minister engaged with students from Mahatma Jyotiba Phule social welfare hostels, schools, and colleges in the Vyra and Madhira constituencies. He emphasized the government's focus on providing quality education, healthcare, and employment opportunities for all citizens. Reddy also highlighted the promotion of 21,000 teachers and the filling of 11,062 teacher positions. He encouraged students to contribute to

nation-building efforts and address issues like drug addiction, urging them to report drug trafficking through Dial-100. To enhance career prospects, Reddy mentioned the establishment of the Young India Skills University and the transformation of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) into Advanced Technology Centers in partnership with Tata Technologies Limited. He further announced plans to create a sports university to promote physical education.

Harish Rao Criticizes CM Revanth Reddy's Changes to Secretariat as 'Vastu Madness'

TPN , Hyderabad: BRS senior MLA Harish Rao has sharply criticized Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy for making changes to the Secretariat based on Vastu principles, calling it "architectural madness." Speaking at a press conference, Harish Rao questioned the sudden shift in policy, particularly criticizing the expenditure of Rs. 4 crore for modifying a gate under the claim of fixing "Vastu dosha."



Rao pointed out that the Secretariat, built during the BRS regime, already complied with green technology and fire safety norms. He reminded the public of Revanth Reddy's previous criticism of such changes when he was in opposition, calling them a waste. However, now that Revanth Reddy is in power, Harish Rao accused him of reversing his stance and making drastic, un-

necessary changes to the building. Rao also mocked the Congress party's tendency to implement frequent, costly changes when in power, calling it an example of the "original Congress mark of change." The political climate surrounding these developments reflects growing tensions between the Congress and BRS over leadership priorities and governance approaches in Telangana.

Telangana Health Minister Urges Public Cooperation for Caste Census

TPN , Hyderabad : Telangana Health Minister C. Damodar Raja Narasimha on Wednesday urged the public to cooperate with officials during the ongoing caste census, emphasizing its importance for the upliftment of economically and politically weaker sections in the state.

Narasimha highlighted that this is the first caste census since independence, noting that the British first conducted it in 1831, and it had not been carried out by the Indian government since. He addressed the gathering in Sanga Reddy, explaining that the survey involves enumerators recording responses



from approximately four lakh Paichilu families in the district. Each survey will include 75 questions covering 55 topics related to various castes.

The minister also pointed out that socio-economic data will be collected as part of the census, which aims to gather information to promote development for underprivileged communities based on their caste and economic conditions. Narasimha stressed that this survey was promised by Congress leader Rahul Gandhi during the 2022 Bharat Jodo Yatra.

The caste census is expected to be completed within a month, with the aim of fostering greater inclusion and providing targeted support for marginalized groups.

HYDRA Officials Visit Bangalore for Pond Restoration and Disaster Management Study

TPN , Hyderabad : In a bid to enhance the conservation of ponds and disaster management strategies, officials from the Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring Protection (HYDRA) department, led by Commissioner Ranganath, departed for Bangalore today. The two-day visit aims to study the successful rehabilitation of ponds and disaster management systems implemented by the Karnataka government.

HYDRA has earned significant praise for its efforts in demolishing illegal structures on water bodies and working towards the protection of ponds. Despite facing some opposition and false propaganda, the organization continues to enjoy the support of the public, who strongly advocate for the restoration of ponds and removal of unauthorized constructions.

The officials will first visit the Karnataka State Natural Disaster Monitoring Centre, where Ranganath will meet with senior scientists to discuss the integration of sensor technology in monitoring sewage systems. The team will also tour various ponds in the core city of Bangalore, including the famous Donhalli pond near Electronic City, developed by Infosys, to



explore best practices and technologies in pond management.

On the second day, Ranganath and his team will meet with Anand Malligavad, known as the "Lake Man of India," to discuss the Karnataka Tank

Conservation Authority Act, 2014. Following the study tour, Ranganath will draft a plan for the restoration of ponds in Hyderabad, raising anticipation for future decisions regarding the protection and management of city ponds.

HYDRA Issues Notices to 50 More Encroachers in Hyderabad



TPN , Hyderabad: The Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring Protection (HYDRA) has stepped up its efforts against the encroachment of government land and public spaces, issuing notices to 50 more individuals in the city. These notices demand the immediate vacation of the occupied properties within 15 days. Failure to comply will result in demolitions, as warned by the authorities.

In a recent crackdown, HYDRA demolished a room constructed on a road in Mansoorabad after a notice was issued a week ago. However, it was noted that some encroachers have not responded to previous notices. As part of ongoing efforts, HYDRA officials are also focusing on identifying and clearing encroachments along public parks, footpaths, and spaces designated for parks in various layouts. Additionally, the authorities are working to define the Full Tank Level (FTL) and buffer zones for ponds and lakes in Hyderabad to prevent further encroachments in those areas. HYDRA has committed to ensuring the protection of public property and government spaces by targeting illegal occupants and taking strict action. Demolition efforts are expected to continue through the end of this month as part of these efforts.

Traffic Advisory Issued Ahead of Telangana CM's Visit to Bhongiri

TPN , Hyderabad: The Rachakonda police have issued a traffic advisory in anticipation of Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's visit to the Yadadri-Bhongiri district on Friday, November 8. To ensure smooth traffic flow and minimize disruptions, several diversions will be in place for heavy vehicles in the Bhongiri zone from 8:00 AM until the conclusion of the CM's tour.

Traffic diversions include:

- Heavy vehicles traveling from the Nalgonda underpass bridge towards Bolepally will be rerouted through Nagireddypally X Road to Valigonda.
- Vehicles coming from Choutupal towards Bolepally will be diverted via Sherigala Road, Pedda Kondur, and Pochampally.

The Traffic Police have urged the public to plan their routes accordingly and avoid the affected areas during these times. They also requested the cooperation of citizens to ensure a hassle-free visit.

13 Arrested in Hyderabad for Illegal Gaming; Rs 1.3 Lakh Seized

TPN , Hyderabad: A late-night raid by the commissioner's task force, West Zone, resulted in the arrest of 13 individuals involved in illegal gaming activities. The raid took place at two gaming houses located under the Jubilee Hills and Film Nagar police stations. Authorities seized playing cards and cash totaling ₹1,33,990.

Among those arrested were two organizers, Yennapusula Malla Reddy, 45, and Mohammed Nayeemuddin, 63, who were previously involved in similar activities. Both were taken into custody and handed over to the respective police stations, along with the 13 others.

Yennapusula Malla Reddy had been arrested earlier in July for a similar offense related to illegal gaming. A case has been registered, and investigations are ongoing.

Installation of Telangana Thalli Statue at Secretariat Progressing Rapidly

TPN , Hyderabad: The installation of the Telangana Thalli statue in front of the Bahubali Gate at the Secretariat is moving ahead swiftly, with completion expected soon. Reports indicate that the unveiling is planned to coincide with senior Congress leader Sonia Gandhi's birthday on December 9.

The project, estimated to cost up to Rs 6 crore, involves excavation work inside the Secretariat premises using JCB machines. Chief Minister Revanth Reddy had previously emphasized that the statue should embody the culture and identity of the state.

The Congress government had previously closed the gate due to vastu concerns but has now cleared the way for the installation. Meanwhile, Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) Working President KT Rama Rao (KTR) had objected to the placement of the statue, calling for the removal of Rajiv Gandhi's statue in favor of Telangana Thalli. KTR had stated that after BRS forms its government, the Rajiv Gandhi statue would be replaced.



In response, Chief Minister Revanth Reddy claimed KTR's intentions were to install a statue of his father, KCR. Reddy argued that the space near the Telangana Martyrs' Memorial would be more appropriate for Rajiv Gandhi's statue, stressing that the Secretariat should not be a place for 'drunkards' and 'thieves.' Reddy also questioned why BRS never considered installing Telangana Thalli's statue during its decade-long rule.

Crucial Turning Point in Agri Gold Case as Court Considers ED Charge Sheet

TPN , Telangana : In a significant development in the Agri Gold case, the court has considered the charge sheet filed by the Enforcement Directorate (ED). The case revolves around the alleged cheating of over 32 lakh customers, with a staggering amount of Rs 6,380 crore collected by the company. The ED has attached assets worth Rs 4,141 crore across multiple states, including Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Odisha, and Andaman &

Nicobar.

The assets of Agri Gold's Managing Director, Avva Venkata Rama Rao, along with those of Avva Venkata Seshu Narayana and Avva Hema Sundara, have also been seized. In a major revelation, the ED discovered that funds were transferred through 130 shell companies, with Venkata Rama Rao allegedly diverting the funds to personal accounts.

The ED further stated that the diverted funds were invested in sectors such as power, real estate, entertainment, and pharmaceuticals. The charge sheet accuses Agri Gold of cheating its customers by promising high returns, while secretly diverting crores of rupees for personal gain. This marks a crucial turning point in the case, as the ED continues its investigation into the financial misconduct surrounding the Agri Gold company.

Over 6,000 Fines Issued in One Day for Helmet-less Driving in Hyderabad



TPN , Hyderabad: Traffic violations have been on the rise in Hyderabad, with the latest crackdown revealing alarming statistics. On the first day of a special enforcement initiative launched on November 5, the Hyderabad traffic police issued fines to 6,631 motorists for riding without helmets. Another 1,503 fines were imposed for driving against traffic.

The initiative, aimed at curbing helmet-less riding and wrong-side driving, was launched by the Hyderabad police following a concerning increase in road accidents. In addition to helmet violations, the police took action against 901 individuals in the past 15 days for improperly driving private vehicles. Strict penalties have also been imposed for unauthorized use of sirens, which are reserved for emergency vehicles such as police cars and ambulances.

Hyderabad has seen a significant increase in road accidents. In 2023, there were 2,312 accidents, up from 2,018 in 2022, resulting in 280 fatalities. Pedestrian deaths alone increased to 121 last year.

With 266,509 signal jumping violations recorded over the past 10 months, these troubling statistics highlight the urgent need for enhanced enforcement and public awareness to curb the rising number of accidents and fatalities on the city's roads.

TGSRTC Launches Home Delivery Service in Hyderabad

TPN , Hyderabad: The Telangana State Road Transport Corporation (TGSRTC) has introduced home delivery services under the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) limits. This pilot project, which commenced in Hyderabad, currently covers 31 areas, with plans to extend to other districts in the near future. Key areas included in the launch are MGBS, JBS, CBS, Dil-sukhnagar, KPHB, Uppal, Kushaiguda, Ranigunj, Jeedimetla, Santoshnagar, Auto Nagar, Cherlapalli, Medipally, and SR Nagar.

The service allows customers to send and receive parcels at their doorsteps. Parcels and parcel covers are collected from designated TGSRTC logistics

centers by agents and delivered directly to customers' addresses across the city. TGSRTC officials have encouraged people to utilize this service to further strengthen its logistics network.

The home delivery charges are:

- 0-1 kg: Rs 50
- 1-5 kg: Rs 60
- 5-10 kg: Rs 65
- 10-20 kg: Rs 70
- 20-30 kg: Rs 75
- Over 30 kg: Rs 75 plus applicable charges for additional weight.

Debt Leads to Tragic Suicide in Nizamabad; Father and Daughter Jump into Godavari



TPN , Hyderabad: Debt has tragically claimed the lives of a father and daughter in Nizamabad district, as the family was unable to bear the harassment from moneylenders. The incident occurred near the Godavari River at Basara,

where Venu (50), his wife Anuradha, and daughter Purnima (24) took a drastic step due to relentless pressure from local moneylenders.

Venu had borrowed Rs 3 lakh from moneylenders Roshan and Vikas for his small business and had repaid most of the loan along with the interest. However, the moneylenders continued to harass the family, demanding repayment through compound interest and threatening to harm Venu's wife and daughter if the debt was not fully cleared.

In an act of despair, the family jumped into the Godavari River. Local fishermen managed to rescue Anuradha, but Venu's body was found later. Search operations are ongoing to recover the body of Purnima. This tragic incident highlights the severe consequences of financial pressure and the exploitation by moneylenders.

Contractor Kidnaps Mother Over Debt Dispute in Rajanna Siricilla



TPN , Rajanna Siricilla: A shocking and inhumane incident occurred in Rajanna Siricilla district when a contractor from Maharashtra forcibly kidnapped the mother of a stone mason after a payment dispute. The incident has caused an uproar in the Vemulawada Urban Mandal of the district.

Pallapu Srinu, a stone mason from Kodumunja village, had acted as an intermediary between Lalu Devakar, a contractor from Maharashtra, and laborers

from Chhattisgarh for a sugarcane plantation project in Karnataka. Srinu arranged the workers for Lalu, who paid Rs. 3.80 lakhs for their services. However, when the workers failed to show up, a dispute arose, and Lalu demanded that Srinu repay the money.

In an extreme move, Lalu Devakar and his team arrived at Srinu's house in Kodumunja R&R Colony and forcibly abducted Srinu's mother, Pallapu Bhima Bai, threatening her to force Srinu into repaying the debt. The family members immediately filed a complaint with the police, and a case was registered. Authorities have launched an investigation into the matter. This disturbing act has highlighted the dangerous consequences of unresolved financial disputes and the lengths to which some individuals may go to settle them.

Food Poisoning Incidents Threaten the Credibility of Ashram Schools in Erstwhile Adilabad



TPN , Adilabad: Once considered a pillar of quality education and reliable food for tribal communities, Ashram schools run by the Tribal Welfare Department in erstwhile Adilabad are facing a growing credibility crisis. These schools, which serve over 33,000 students across 133 institutions, have been experiencing repeated food poisoning incidents, raising serious concerns about the management and safety of the schools.

The region, which includes Adilabad, Kumram Bheem Asifabad, Nirmal, and Mancherial districts, has seen multiple such incidents. In a recent event, 60 students from an Ashram school in Wankidi Mandal fell ill after consuming dinner, with one student, Shailaja, in critical condition. Two others recovered after treatment in private hospitals. Earlier, in October 2024, a Class IX student, Madavi Gangothri, died after consuming food at her hostel in Indervelli. Reports show that at least five students die each year in the area due to food poisoning or other health issues like fever. The recurring nature of these incidents points to significant lapses in the management of the schools, particularly in terms of hygiene and food quality. Wardens are accused of neglecting their duties, often administering the schools remotely from towns without ensuring proper supervision or food safety practices. There are also concerns about the quality of food, with fresh vegetables and purified water not being used consistently in meal preparation.

Khusbu Gupta, ITDA-Utanoor Project Officer, responded to the concerns, stating that measures have been taken to prevent outside food, ensure wardens taste the food, and improve inspections. Regular checks on water plants and kitchens, as well as anemia tests for students, are part of the ongoing efforts to prevent such incidents. Despite these steps, the continued food poisoning cases highlight a need for more effective management and oversight in these institutions.

9 DSPs, SDPOs, and ACPs Transferred in Major Telangana Police Shuffle

TPN , Hyderabad: In a significant reshuffling aimed at filling vacancies and redistributing duties, the Telangana state government transferred nine police officers across various positions on Wednesday, November 6. The changes, based on the recommendations of the Police Establishment Board, impact deputy superintendents of police (DSPs), sub-divisional police officers (SDPOs), and assistant commissioners of police (ACPs).

Notable transfers include SR Damodar Reddy, who was posted as DSP in Amberpet, Hyderabad, to fill a vacant position. G Mahesh Babu, DSP at the District Crime Records Bureau in Jagtial, was moved to the Police Training College in Karimnagar.

B Ramanujam, previously DSP at the PTC Karimnagar, was appointed SDPO of Kagaznagar in Komrambheem Asifabad, while A Karunakar was transferred from Kagaznagar to SDPO of Asifabad.

Further changes saw K Krishna Kishore, DSP at the District Crime Records Bureau in Wanaparthy, appointed as SDPO of Thorur in Mahabubabad, and P Ravinder Reddy, DSP of the Nirmal bureau, moved to ACP at the City Crime Record Bureau in Khammam. D Prasanna Kumar, ACP in Khammam, will now serve as SDPO of Medak.

These transfers aim to optimize operational efficiency within the state police force.



Minister Ponnam Prabhakar Assists Student with Financial Support in Husnabad



TPN , Husnabad: Minister Ponnam Prabhakar extended financial support to a student facing economic hardships by presenting a check of Rs 1.5 lakh to Lavanya Ramesh Lakshmi, the second daughter of a couple from Ballu Naik Tanda in Husnabad mandal. Lavanya recently secured a medical seat at Mittapalli Surabhi Medical College in Siddipet district but was struggling to manage hostel expenses due to financial constraints.

The check was provided to help cover the costs associated with her accommodation and ensure she could continue her education without further financial burden. Minister Ponnam Prabhakar's gesture reflects the government's commitment to supporting deserving students in pursuing higher education despite financial challenges.

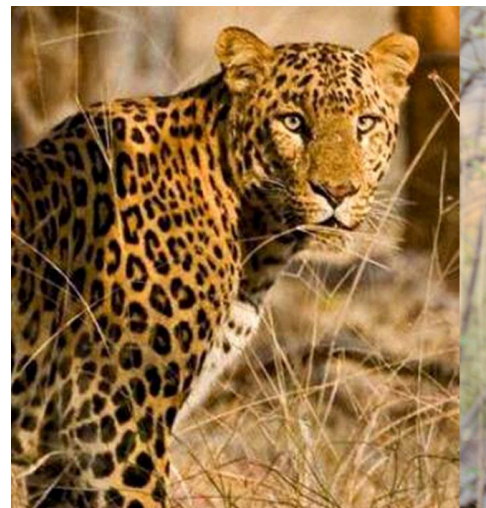
Telangana: DCA Seizes Overpriced Medicine from Medchal Manufacturing Unit



TPN , Hyderabad: The Telangana Drug Control Administration (DCA) seized overpriced medication from a manufacturing unit in Medchal Malkajiri on Thursday, November 7. During a raid, DCA officials discovered that a 5-gram pack of Mupiger Ointment, which is supposed to be priced at Rs 101.45, was being sold at Rs 144. The price exceeds the Maximum Retail Price (MRP), which, including a 12% GST, should not exceed Rs 113.62 per 5-gram pack.

The ointment, manufactured by Medzine Life Sciences, was found to be sold for Rs 30.37 more than the stipulated price, violating the Drugs (Prices Control) Order, 2013. The DCA has now initiated further investigation into the matter.

Villagers on High Alert as Tiger and Leopard Roam in Lakshettipet Forest



TPN , Hyderabad: Villagers in the Lakshettipet forest range of Mancherial district are on edge as both a tiger and a leopard have been spotted roaming the area, causing significant concern. The tiger, which is currently migrating, arrived in Lakshettipet from the Jannaram forest range two weeks ago. Recently, it was reported to have killed a cow in the Medaram section and was later seen near the Buggagutta forest area in the Dharmaram beat of Hajipur mandal.

As a precaution, villagers from Hanumanthapally and Dharmaram have refrained

from taking their livestock into the forest for grazing. Forest officials have intensified their efforts to track the tiger's movements, setting up camera traps and taking measures to protect both the villagers and the wildlife.

Additionally, a leopard has been active in the same region. On October 27, it killed two sheep, which villagers initially believed to be the work of the tiger. However, the forest department confirmed that the leopard was responsible for the attack. Authorities are closely monitoring the situation to ensure public safety.

Hyderabad: Lecturer Arrested for Demanding and Accepting Rs 50,000 Bribe



TPN , Hyderabad: A lecturer from the education department was arrested by the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) on November 7 for demanding and accepting a bribe of Rs. 50,000 in exchange for performing official duties.

The accused, Auti Ravinder, is employed as a lecturer at D.I.E.T College and also serves as a Field Assistant Commissioner (FAC) under the district education officer in Mahabubnagar. He was caught red-handed after he demanded the bribe from a complainant in exchange for facilitating his wife's service seniority for

promotion and financial benefits. ACB officials recovered the bribe amount from Ravinder's possession, and a subsequent test on his right hand fingers confirmed his involvement in the crime. The lecturer was arrested and presented before the First Additional Special Judge for SPE and ACB Cases Court in Nampally, where he was charged with dishonestly performing his duties.

This arrest highlights ongoing efforts by authorities to combat corruption within government departments.



Elon Musk's Role in Trump's Victory: A Digital Power Play

In the days leading up to Donald Trump's victorious election, the media buzzed with uncertainty. Despite claims from traditional outlets that the race was "too close to call," Trump's win was nothing short of a resounding surprise to the legacy media. Was it a miscalculation, or was it the result of wishful thinking? That's a question for another time. Musk, the ultimate risk-taker, had gambled his empire—Tesla, SpaceX, X, and more—in support of Trump, and the bet paid off handsomely.

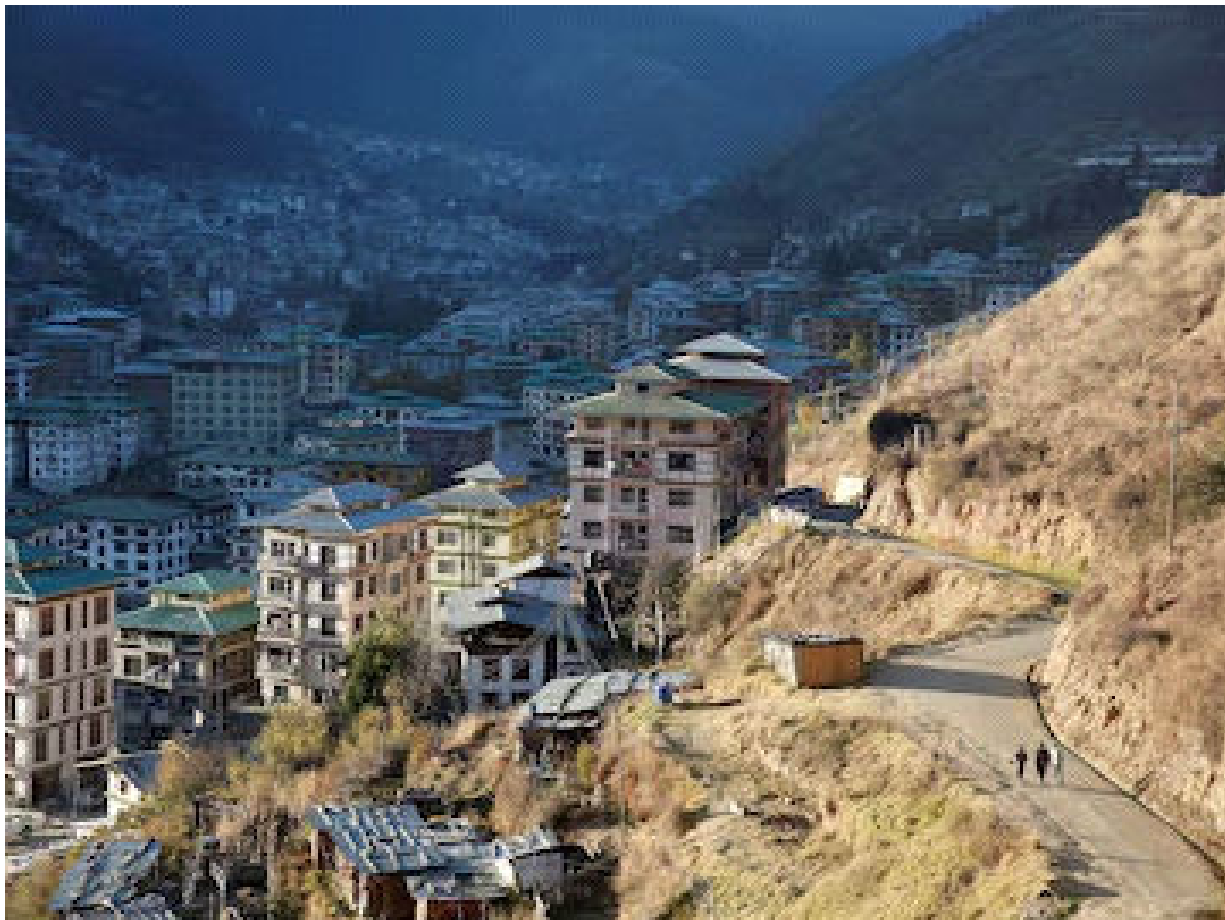
While Musk's influence on Trump's campaign was clear, another key player was podcaster Joe Rogan. With millions of followers across platforms like YouTube and Spotify, Rogan's endorsement of Trump in the final days of the election could have been the tipping point. Musk's own reach, with over 200 million followers on X, dwarfs that of any traditional media outlet. The power of these digital platforms to influence the election cannot be overstated, as they offer unprecedented access to voters on a global scale.



As Election Day drew to a close, Musk took to X's live audio feature, Spaces, for a candid chat with his followers. Over 17,000 people tuned in to hear Musk's thoughts on the high-stakes election, as he fielded questions and provided his analysis. Musk was confident in Trump's potential to win, especially after seeing steady gains in key swing states. At one point, Musk boldly predicted that Trump would sweep all seven of them—an outcome that turned out to be true.

Musk's influence on the election, particularly through his platform, highlighted a shift in the political landscape, where digital figures now rival traditional media in their power to shape public opinion. As the election results unfolded, it was clear that Musk's digital strategy had played a pivotal role in securing Trump's success.

China's Aggressive Expansion into Bhutanese Territory: Satellite Images Expose Shocking Details



Recent reports have revealed troubling new evidence of China's growing encroachment into Bhutanese territory, with satellite imagery showing the construction of 22 villages and settlements by China in land historically and internationally recognized as Bhutanese. This aggressive move, which began in 2016, has resulted in China occupying over 825 square kilometers of land, amounting to more than 2 percent of Bhutan's total territorial area.

The ongoing encroachment is part of a broader, calculated strategy employed by China to exert control over Bhutan's border regions. This six-stage strategy dates back to the early 1990s when China began deploying Tibetan herders into disputed areas, leading to clashes with Bhutanese pastoralists. As a result, the Bhutanese herders were forced to retreat from their own grazing lands. With the withdrawal of these herders, Bhutanese soldiers, who relied on local support for supplies, also pulled back from the region.

Following the withdrawal, China escalated its presence in the area, starting with military pa-

trols and later constructing makeshift outposts. Over time, these outposts became permanent fixtures, with China building roads to connect these sites to towns within Tibet. Eventually, China started constructing entire villages and settlements, further cementing its territorial claims.

This aggressive expansion has sparked significant concerns for Bhutan, which is a small, landlocked country sandwiched between China and India. Despite Bhutan's long-standing diplomatic ties with India and its firm stance on defending its sovereignty, it now faces increasing pressure from China's continued territorial advances. Bhutan has yet to comment officially on the construction of these villages, but the satellite evidence presents an alarming picture of China's ongoing encroachment.

As Bhutan and China share a long-standing border dispute, the satellite imagery underscores the strategic importance of this region to China and the extent to which it is willing to go to assert control over disputed territories.

BJP Promises Uniform Civil Code for Jharkhand, Exempting Tribals



The BJP has made a significant pledge in its election manifesto for the upcoming Jharkhand assembly polls, promising to implement the Uniform Civil Code (UCC) in the state, though it would exclude tribal communities from its provisions. The announcement, made by Union Home Minister Amit Shah on November 3 in Ranchi, aims to strengthen the BJP's stance on national integration and cultural unity. Shah also promised that the party would address concerns regarding "Bangladeshi infiltration" in the region by removing illegal immigrants and returning occupied land to the state's tribal communities.

The UCC, long a core issue for the BJP, seeks to create a unified legal framework for personal matters such as marriage, divorce, and inheritance, applicable to all citizens regardless of religion, caste, or community. However, in Jharkhand, the BJP has tailored its approach to appeal to the tribal electorate by excluding them from the scope of the UCC, acknowledging the unique cultural and religious practices of these communities. This move is seen as an attempt to balance the BJP's support for national uniformity with sensitivity toward tribal identities.

Jharkhand's Chief Minister, Hemant Soren, and his party, the Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM), have opposed the BJP's UCC promise. Soren has made it clear that the UCC and the National Register of Citizens (NRC) will not be implemented in the state. Instead, the JMM has advocated for a separate Sarna Code, which would recognize

the unique religious practices of tribal people.

The issue of illegal immigration has also become a key election talking point. The Jharkhand High Court has been hearing a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) that alleges significant infiltration of Bangladeshis, especially in regions like Santhal Pargana. The court has ordered the formation of a fact-finding committee to investigate these claims, although the Jharkhand government has challenged this interim order in the Supreme Court. The BJP has used the issue of "Bangladeshi infiltrators" to position itself as the guardian of tribal land and culture.

While the BJP's position on the UCC and illegal immigration is aimed at consolidating its support among the state's tribals, it has faced criticism from opposition parties. Critics argue that the UCC is a tool to undermine Muslim personal laws, rather than promote equality across communities. Some also question the BJP's intentions with the Sarna Code, as it challenges the party's longstanding efforts to integrate tribals into the Hindu fold.

As election day approaches, both the BJP and JMM are expected to sharpen their rhetoric on these contentious issues. The outcome will depend on whether these issues resonate with the voters, particularly the tribal communities, whose cultural identity and political influence are central to the state's electoral dynamics. The results of the election will be announced on November 23.

Why America Chose Donald Trump Again: The Big Picture

Donald Trump secured a decisive victory in the 2024 US Presidential Election, winning a second term in the White House by defeating Vice President Kamala Harris. Despite early predictions from polls suggesting a tightly contested race, Trump triumphed comfortably, surpassing expectations with a strong showing across key battleground states.

The minister's remarks come amid rising speculations about how Trump's return could shape the global political and economic landscape, especially for India, which has experienced growing cooperation with the United States in recent years.

India's Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) has strongly condemned the surveillance of Indian diplomats in Canada, calling the actions "totally unacceptable." The statement follows reports that Canadian authorities have placed Indian diplomats under scrutiny, a move that has sparked diplomatic tensions between the two countries. India has urged Canada to take immediate action to ensure the safety and security of its diplomats, emphasizing that such surveillance violates international norms and diplomat-



ic conventions. This development comes at a time of heightened tensions between the two nations, as recent incidents have already strained bilateral relations.

As Donald Trump prepares for a potential second term, experts suggest that while US support for India remains bipartisan, Trump's approach may tilt further in India's favor. However, analysts caution that India must also prepare for surprises given Trump's unpredictability. Key areas of concern include the future of the H1B visa program, economic dynamics, and regional challenges, including posturing from countries like Bangladesh and Pakistan. Despite potential disruptions, many believe Trump's administration could continue strengthening ties with India, particularly in defense and trade.

CM M.K. Stalin Strengthens Tamil Nadu-Taiwan Ties with Major Investments

Chennai: Tamil Nadu's strategic ties with Taiwan have deepened in recent years, with the state becoming a major destination for Taiwanese investment. On August 18, Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin inaugurated a Rs 706-crore residential complex for Foxconn's female workers at Sriperumbudur, 40 km from Chennai, highlighting the state's role as a key hub for global manufacturing. The complex, designed to house 18,720 workers, reflects the region's growing importance in Taiwan's supply chain, particularly for electronics manufacturing.

Foxconn, the world's largest electronics manufacturer, operates its second-largest workforce in Tamil Nadu, with over 60,000 employees. The state's relationship with Foxconn has been marked by cooperation and investment, including the personal gesture of state industries minister T.R.B. Rajaa driving Foxconn chairman Young Liu from Chennai airport to Sriperumbudur,



signaling Tamil Nadu's commitment to fostering strong industrial partnerships.

Tamil Nadu's connections with Taiwan extend beyond Foxconn. According to data from the Taipei Economic and Cultural Center (TECC) in Chennai, the state hosts 270 Taiwanese companies, making it a crucial location for Taiwanese manufacturing. Among the largest Taiwanese employers in Tamil Nadu are electronics firms Pegatron and Delta, each

employing around 20,000 workers. Lotus, a subsidiary of Taiwanese footwear company Feng Tay, has a workforce of 40,000.

Taiwan's footprint in Tamil Nadu is further expanding, with major footwear companies like Shoe Town, Feng Tay, and Pou Chen establishing factories in the region. Pou Chen, the world's largest athletic footwear manufacturer, secured a deal in 2023 to set up a Rs 2,302 crore unit in the state.



Government Committed To Eradicating Terrorism: Amit Shah

Union Home Minister Amit Shah reiterated the Indian government's firm commitment to eradicating terrorism, emphasizing a strong, unified approach involving both central and state security agencies. Addressing an anti-terrorism conference on Thursday, Shah underscored the need for coordinated efforts to combat terrorism, noting that while law and order is a state subject, terrorism knows no boundaries.

Shah praised the Modi government for its decisive strategy against terrorism since 2014, highlighting a 70 percent reduction in terror incidents compared to the previous decade. He credited this success to the collaborative efforts of central and state governments, particularly in regions like Jammu and Kashmir, areas affected by Left-Wing Extremism, and the northeastern states. The Home Minister also pointed to significant progress in reducing the "shelf life" of terrorists, saying it has dropped from two years to mere days, thanks to the government's zero-tolerance policy towards terrorism.

In his address, Shah called for greater synergy between state police forces and central agencies, urging police chiefs to invoke the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA) when necessary. He praised the National Investigation Agency (NIA) for its effectiveness, with nearly 95 percent of chargesheets leading to convictions in the 632 cases investigated by the agency. To further enhance counter-terrorism efforts, Shah highlighted amendments to the NIA Act, expanding its jurisdiction to include terror cases abroad. Additionally, the UAPA amendments now allow for property confiscation and designation of individuals or organizations as terrorists.

Shah revealed a 25-point integrated plan to stop terrorism funding, including measures targeting jihadi terrorism and Left-Wing Extremism. He also discussed the expansion of the Multi-Agency Centre (MAC), which monitors emerging threats like cyber terrorism, narco-terrorism, and radicalization. The conference is aimed at fostering coordination among various security agencies and experts to strengthen India's defense against terrorism.

The Consulate General of India stated that the decision was taken after Canadian security authorities expressed their "inability to provide minimum security protection" to the organizers of the camp.



The life certificate is a vital document for Indian nationals residing abroad to ensure the continuation of their pensions. These consular camps were organized to assist Indian citizens and Canadian residents who needed to submit life certificates, a routine process for pension-related matters.

The decision to cancel the camps comes in the wake of violent incidents orchestrated by Khalistani extremists at previous consular camps held in Brampton, Surrey, and Vancouver. The latest attack took place in Brampton on Sunday, when a consular camp was targeted by extremists, disrupting the normal consular work. During this incident, Khalistani flags were seen outside the Hindu Sabha Mandir, where the camp was being held, and the

safety of those attending was jeopardized. In a statement, the Indian High Commission in Ottawa condemned the attacks and blamed "anti-India elements" for the disturbances. Despite the disruptions, the High Commission reported that over 1,000 life certificates had been issued to applicants at the Brampton camp. The consulate emphasized the concerns for the safety of both Indian nationals and other applicants, noting the risk posed by such violent actions.

"Living in a democracy is about recognizing that our point of view won't always win out," Obama said, "and being willing to accept the peaceful transfer of power."

In 2020, Trump's failure to accept Joe Biden's victory sparked a series of controversies, culminating in the deadly attack on the Capitol, which left deep scars in American politics. Trump's refusal to concede and his baseless claims of election fraud led to a turbulent period that many critics saw as a direct challenge to the integrity of the U.S. democratic system.

Joe Biden's name may not have been on the ballot, but the consequences of his reelection bid are likely to tarnish his legacy. Kamala Harris' decisive defeat in the presidential race is widely seen as an extension of Biden's failure to step aside sooner, allowing the Democratic Party to lose control of the White House.

Biden's decision to delay his exit from the political stage, maintaining an intention to seek reelection until mid-2024, is coming under increasing scrutiny. The decision, critics argue, sealed the party's fate and made Trump's second term a reality. The 81-year-old president's reluctance to recognize growing voter concerns—over his age, economic instability post-pandemic, and the ongoing crisis at the US-Mexico border—contributed to a lack of enthusiasm among key Democratic voters.

Andrew Yang, who had a brief presidential run in 2020, placed much of the blame on Biden's failure to relinquish his grip on the race. "If he had stepped down in January instead of July, we may be in a very different place," said Yang.



Although Biden's first term brought successes—leading the US through the pandemic, securing global support for Ukraine, and passing a \$1 trillion infrastructure bill—the shadow of his second-term defeat looms large. His presidency was framed as a restoration of dignity and stability after Trump's chaotic tenure, but that vision will now be overshadowed by his inability to secure a second term, leaving Trump poised for a return to power.

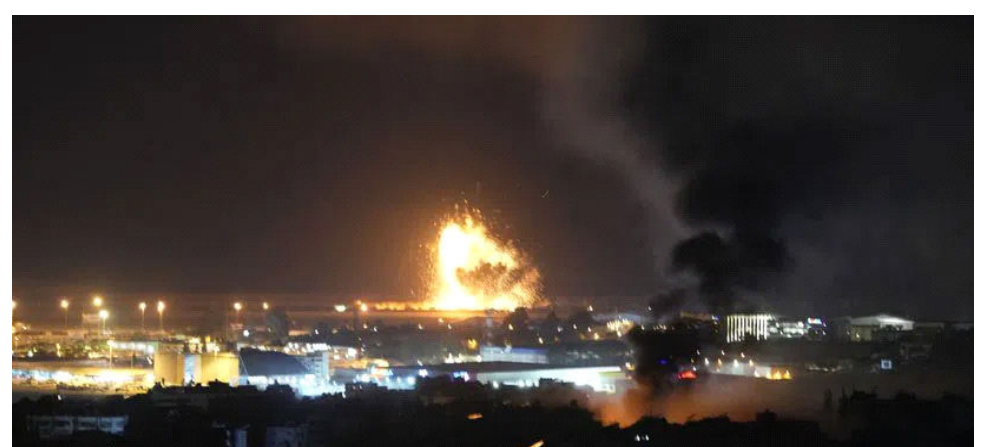

Israel launches airstrikes on Beirut suburbs, expands Gaza operations

Early Thursday, multiple airstrikes targeted Beirut's southern suburbs, including a strike near Lebanon's only international airport. The Israeli military had previously issued an evacuation notice for the site, warning of Hezbollah facilities in the area, although they did not provide further details on the exact targets. The strikes come amid ongoing military action between Israel and Hezbollah, which has intensified in recent weeks.

Forces (IDF) confirmed an expansion of their ground operations in northern Gaza. Israeli forces have moved into Beit Lahiya, a heavily bombed town where Israel claims Hamas militants have been regrouping. This escalation marks a continuation of the Israeli military's aggressive response following the deadly Hamas assault on Israel on October 7, 2023, which left around 1,200 Israelis dead and more than 250 people abducted.

The violence in Gaza has been catastrophic, with over 43,000 Palestinians reported dead, according to Palestinian health officials, though these figures do not differentiate between civilians and combatants. More than half of the casualties are said to be women and children. In the aftermath of the assault, Israel has heavily bombed Gaza, focusing on areas where Hamas militants are believed to be entrenched. The humanitarian toll continues to rise, as thousands of Palestinians remain trapped under rubble in the besieged enclave.

Adani Energy Solutions Shares Drop 9% as MSCI Excludes Stock

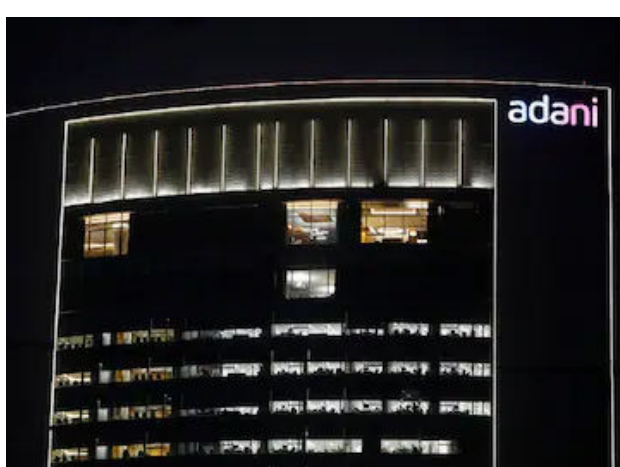
Shares of Adani Energy Solutions plunged over 9% on November 7 after the stock was excluded from the MSCI Global Standard Index in its November review. The market had been expecting the stock's inclusion, but MSCI opted to delay its decision due to ongoing concerns about the company's free float.

The exclusion came as a blow to investors, especially after MSCI had raised expectations for Adani Energy Solutions' entry into the prestigious index. In its latest review, MSCI confirmed that it would not be adding the stock, citing issues related to its free float—specifically, a lack of clarity regarding the company's shareholding structure.

MSCI explained that Adani Energy Solutions had been issued a show-cause notice by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for potential wrongful categorization of certain shareholdings. This notice raised concerns about the true extent of the company's freely available shares for international investors, prompting MSCI to withhold any changes to the stock's foreign inclusion factor (FIF) and domestic inclusion factor (DIF) in its index.

MSCI's decision also means there will be no increase in the number of shares (NOS) for Adani Energy Solutions as part of the November 2024 Index Review. The firm indicated that the stock would remain under scrutiny until further clarification is provided by SEBI regarding its free float.

Meanwhile, the latest MSCI review did see other stocks, such as BSE, Voltas, Alkem Laboratories, Kalyan Jewellers, and Oberoi Realty, make their way into the Global Standard Index. These additions are expected to draw attention from global investors and could lead to increased foreign investments in these companies.



India's Fuel Demand Increases 2.9% , Petrol and LPG Sales See Strong Growth

India's fuel demand saw a 2.9 percent rise in October compared to the same month last year, as per data released by the Petroleum Planning and Analysis Cell (PPAC) of the Ministry of Petroleum. Total fuel consumption in the country reached 20.04 million metric tons during the month.

Petrol sales experienced a notable surge, rising by 8.6 percent year-on-year to 3.41 million tons. This increase reflects stronger demand for personal vehicles and transportation fuels, especially as the festive season in



India typically boosts consumption.

Diesel consumption, which is a key indicator of industrial and transportation activity, saw a modest increase of 0.1 percent, totaling 7.64 million tons in Oc-

tober. While this was a slower growth rate compared to petrol, it still indicates steady demand in the commercial and logistics sectors.

Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), commonly used for cooking, also saw a significant uptick, with sales growing 9.3 percent to reach 2.73 million tons. The rise in LPG consumption is largely attributed to the government's efforts to expand household connections under its Ujjwala Yojana scheme, aimed at providing clean cooking fuel to rural households.

In contrast, naphtha sales saw a slight decline of 1.1 percent, totaling 1.18 million tons. Naphtha is primarily used in the petrochemical industry, and its decrease in sales could be linked to changes in industrial demand or production shifts.

Meanwhile, sales of bitumen, a key material for road construction, fell 7.2 percent, reflecting possible slowdowns in infrastructure projects. On the other hand, fuel oil consumption saw a sharp 23.4 percent increase, driven by higher demand from industries relying on fuel oil for power generation and other uses.

Tata Steel Reports Strong Recovery with Profit in Q2 FY2024

Tata Steel Ltd. reported a strong recovery in its financial performance for the July-September quarter (Q2 FY2024), posting a net profit of Rs 833 crore. This marked a significant rebound from a loss of Rs 6,196 crore in the same quarter last year.

The company's revenue from operations for the quarter stood at Rs 53,905 crore, reflecting a 3% decline year-on-year. However, the net profit showed a positive shift, driven by improvements in operational efficiency and cost management. Tata Steel also reported an EBITDA of Rs 6,141 crore, with margins of 11.4%, signaling a healthy performance despite the overall revenue dip.

In its quarterly update, Tata Steel



acknowledged challenges in its UK operations, which have been facing losses due to high energy costs and other macroeconomic factors. The company disclosed that Tata Steel Europe Ltd (TSE), its wholly owned subsidiary, is exposed to climate-related risks

that may impact future cash flows. The company is also undergoing a significant transformation with plans to transition from traditional blast furnace production to electric arc furnace-based production. This move is part of TSE's decarboni-

sation efforts.

In September 2024, TSE signed a Grant Funding Agreement (GFA) with the UK government for the decarbonisation process, securing government funding alongside the company's commitment to infuse equity into Tata Steel UK (TSUK). The company assured that TSUK now has access to sufficient liquidity to fund its operations, alleviating concerns over the going concern assessment.

Additionally, Tata Steel announced the appointment of Pramod Agrawal as an Independent Director on its board, effective November 6, 2024. Agrawal's appointment was approved by the Nomination and Remuneration Committee.

Australia proposes ban on social media for children under 16

Australia's Prime Minister, Anthony Albanese, has announced a groundbreaking plan to ban social media use for children under the age of 16. Speaking at a news conference on Thursday, Albanese called the new policy "world-leading" and said it was necessary to protect children from the harmful effects of excessive social media use. He cited the increasing physical and mental health risks to children, particularly the dangers posed by harmful body image standards and misogynistic content, which disproportionately affect young people.



regardless of whether they have parental consent or existing social media accounts. The responsibility for enforcing the age restrictions will lie with the social media platforms themselves, with companies expected to prove they are taking reasonable steps to prevent underage users from accessing their services.

"If you're a 14-year-old kid getting this stuff at a time when you're going through life's changes, it can be a really difficult time," Albanese said. "What we're doing is listening and then acting."

The Australian government is taking proactive steps to implement the ban, which could come into effect by the end of 2025. The new policy includes a trial of an age-verification system aimed at blocking children from accessing platforms like Instagram, Facebook, TikTok, and YouTube. Legislation for the ban will be introduced in parliament later this year, and the laws will take effect 12 months after ratification.

Importantly, the ban will apply to all children,

The proposed policy has received support from the opposition Liberal Party, while communications minister Michelle Rowland confirmed that platforms such as Meta's Instagram and Facebook, TikTok, and X (formerly Twitter) would be impacted.

This move positions Australia at the forefront of international efforts to regulate social media use among children. While other countries like France have proposed similar measures, Australia's policy is one of the most stringent to date. The government's bold stance signals a growing recognition of the risks posed by social media to young users and a commitment to protecting children from harmful digital content.

New Android Malware *ToxicPanda* Targets Bank Accounts Over Devices

Cybersecurity researchers have recently uncovered a new and dangerous Android malware known as *ToxicPanda*, which has already infected over 1,500 devices. This banking trojan is designed to steal money from bank accounts and typically spreads through sideloading—where apps are installed from third-party sources instead of official app stores. *ToxicPanda* often disguises itself as popular apps, including Google Chrome, to deceive users into installing it.



Discovered by Cleafly Intelligence last month, *ToxicPanda* was initially thought to be related to another banking trojan, *TgToxic*, which targeted users in Southeast Asia. However, further analysis revealed that the code behind *ToxicPanda* is significantly different, indicating that it is a new threat with its own set of malicious tactics.

The main objective of *ToxicPanda* is to initiate unauthorized money transfers from infected Android devices. It uses methods such as "account takeover" and "On-Device fraud" to bypass security measures set by banks. These include identity verification processes, multi-factor authentication, and behavioral detection systems that aim to flag suspicious transactions.

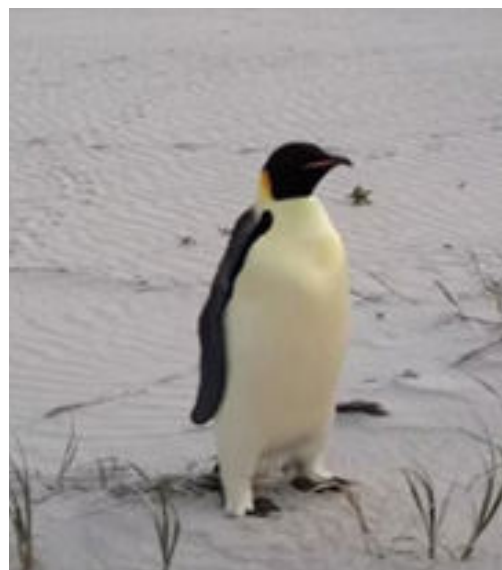
Despite its sophisticated approach, *ToxicPanda* appears to be still in development. Researchers have noted that some of the malware's commands are incomplete, with several placeholders that do not yet serve a functional purpose.

However, the malware has the ability to remotely control a compromised device by exploiting Android's accessibility services. This allows *ToxicPanda* to operate even when the user is not actively using their phone.

As *ToxicPanda* continues to evolve, cybersecurity experts urge Android users to be cautious when sideloading apps and to regularly update their devices to minimize the risk of infection. The rise of such banking trojans underscores the growing threats in the mobile security landscape, particularly for users who may inadvertently download malicious apps from untrusted sources.

Rare Sighting: Emperor Penguin Found on Beach in Western Australia

In an extraordinary and rare event, an emperor penguin has been spotted on a beach in Australia, marking the first recorded sighting of the species so far north. The penguin was found on Ocean Beach in Denmark, Western Australia, on Friday, more than 3,540 kilometers away from its native Antarctic home. The bird appeared malnourished, likely due to its long journey and unfamiliar conditions.



Western Australia, the penguin may have followed an ocean current that carried it further north than usual. "What they tend to do is follow certain currents where they can find various types of food," Cannell explained. "These currents may have shifted a little further north, bringing the penguin to Australia."

The penguin, described as "way bigger than a seabird," was immediately taken into care by a trained and registered local wildlife carer. The Western Australia Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) confirmed that the penguin is undergoing a rehabilitation process, which is expected to take a few weeks. A spokesperson from the DBCA added that the wildlife carer is receiving support from a DBCA officer to ensure the penguin's recovery.

Local surfer Aaron Fowler, who was one of the first to encounter the penguin, described the moment with awe. "It was massive, much bigger than a seabird. We couldn't believe what we were seeing," he said. "It waddled right up to us, probably about a meter high, and didn't seem shy at all."

This remarkable sighting has sparked much curiosity among researchers. According to Belinda Cannell, a research fellow at the University of

The Science of Forgetting: Why We Forget and How It Can Be Beneficial

Forgetting is an everyday experience. Whether it's walking into a room and forgetting why you went there, or failing to remember someone's name, we all forget things regularly. But why do we forget? Is it a sign of memory impairment, or could there be benefits to forgetting?



The concept of forgetting was first explored by German psychologist Hermann Ebbinghaus in the 19th century, who introduced the "forgetting curve." Ebbinghaus showed that people forget most of the details of new information rapidly, but the rate of forgetting slows down over time. This concept has since been supported by modern neuroscientific research.

Forgetting, however, is not always a negative process. Our brains are constantly bombarded with information, and if we remembered ev-

erything, it would be increasingly difficult to retain what truly matters. To manage this, our brains naturally filter out unimportant details. Nobel laureate Eric Kandel and other researchers have shown that memory formation occurs when synaptic connections between neurons

are strengthened. Paying attention to something reinforces these connections, while irrelevant details are forgotten. This mechanism helps us prioritize important memories, even though distractions and memory impairments may increase with age.

Forgetting also plays a role in helping us adapt to new information. Consider your daily commute. Over time, your brain strengthens memories of your regular route. However, if a road is closed and you take a new route, your brain needs to adjust. It does so by weakening old memory connections and creating new ones. This flexibility is vital for adapting to changing environments.

From an evolutionary perspective, forgetting old

information in favor of new memories was crucial for survival. For instance, if a hunter-gatherer repeatedly visited a water source, but one day encountered danger there, their brain needed to update the memory to recognize the location as unsafe.

Interestingly, forgetting may not always be about memory loss but could be linked to our ability to access memories. Research with rodents has shown that memories can be reactivated by stimulating specific brain connections, demonstrating how our brains can "revive" forgotten memories under certain conditions.

In essence, forgetting is a complex process that serves both functional and adaptive purposes, helping us navigate and survive in an ever-changing world.

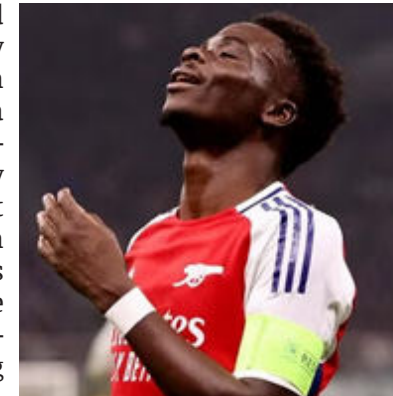

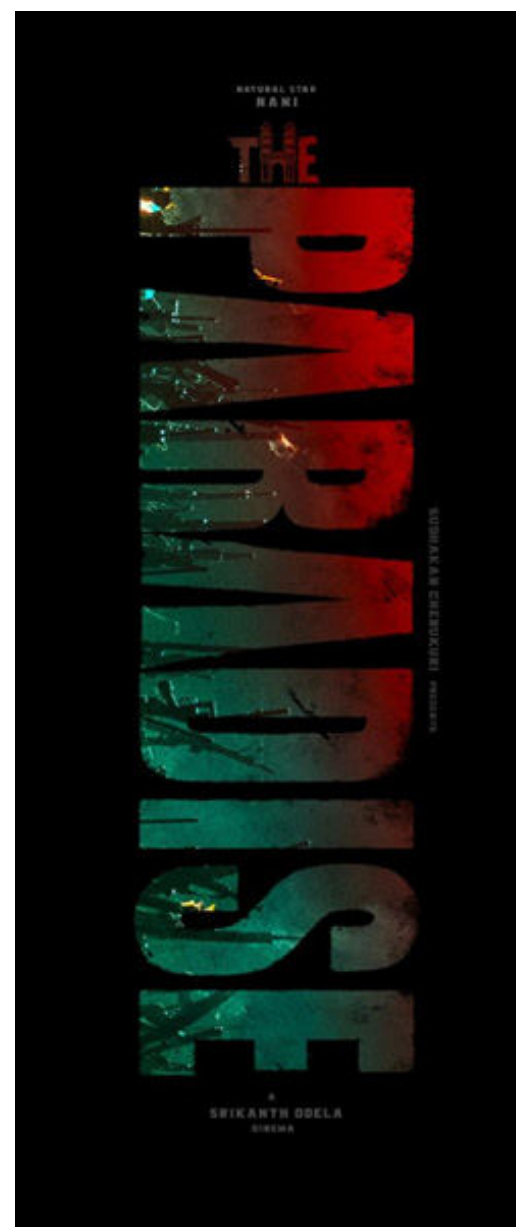

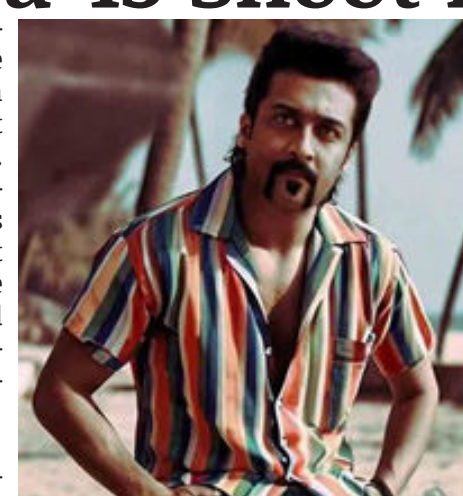
