

He cited examples, including the establishment of Kia Motors in Anantapur, electronics in Chittoor, wind turbine production in Nellore, renewable energy projects in Kurnool, and cell phone and aqua industries in East and West Godavari. TPN, Andhra Pradesh: YS Jagan Mohan Reddy has become known for his selective approach to addressing topics in the media, often presenting his views in a controlled manner without fielding additional questions. This approach was evident again today.

When an English journalist brought up Sharmila's recent call for Jagan to resign as an MLA if he had no intention of attending the assembly, Jagan's response was swift and dismissive.

"There's no need to discuss my sisters here. Her party (Congress) holds just a 1.7% vote share—that's all there is to it," Jagan remarked, using the low vote share to effectively downplay Sharmila's relevance.

In light of the ongoing legal disputes between Jagan and both Sharmila and their mother, Vijayamma, his dismissive stance was somewhat anticipated. However, today, Jagan took extra effort to minimize Sharmila's significance by reducing her position to the vote percentage of her party, rendering her almost irrelevant in his press statement.



Minister Durgesh Delivers Fiery Response to YCP Leader Botsa

TPN, Amaravati: In a passionate and powerful address to the Legislative Council, State Tourism, Culture, and Cinematography Minister Kandula Durgesh took on YCP leader Botsa, making it clear that the coalition government is unwavering in its commitment to implementing the "Super Six" welfare schemes.

"The previous government reduced pensions to a paltry Rs. 2000 and took five years to raise it to Rs. 3000. In stark contrast, the coalition government increased that Rs. 3000 pension to Rs. 4000 within just 15 days of coming to power! That is the efficiency and dedication of this coalition," thundered Minister Durgesh. Delivering on promises, he elaborated, "We ensured that arrears for April, May, and June were settled at Rs. 3000 per month, followed by Rs. 7000 in July. CAG Reveals Key Details on Previous Government's Financial Status in AP

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India has disclosed important details regarding the financial status of the previous government in Andhra Pradesh. According to the CAG report, as of April 2023, the state's reserve account with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) showed a deficit of Rs. 19 crore, which further increased to Rs. 33 crore by March 2024.

The CAG clarified that there was no actual cash balance in the investment account at the end of the financial year. The government debt for 2022-23 was recorded at Rs. 4,86,151 crore, with public debt accounting for 34 percent of the state's gross product. The CAG report also indicated that in 2023-24, government guarantees amounting to Rs. 2,23,004 crore were issued, and Rs. 69,626 crore was transferred from the consolidated fund to the Public Deposit (PD) accounts.

Other points revealed by the CAG include:

- In 2023-24, 52 paise of each rupee came from tax collections. - The previous government acquired loans amounting to 30 paise of each rupee.
- Additionally, 14 paise per rupee was earned from grantsin-aid, 3 paise from non-tax revenue, and 1 paise from loan
- Of every rupee, 15 paise was spent on salaries, 13 paise on Direct Benefit Transfers (DBTs), and 12 paise on interest pay-

These findings provide insights into the financial management and fiscal policies of the previous government in Andhra Pradesh.

AP Group-2 Mains Exams Postponed

- **Group-2 Mains was initially** scheduled for January 5.
- Candidates requested more time to prepare for the exams.
- Several MLCs appealed to APPSC for a postponement.
- APPSC, considering all appeals, has rescheduled the Group-2 Mains exams to February 23.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Group-2 Mains Exams in Andhra Pradesh have been postponed. Originally set for January 5, the APPSC (Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission) has now rescheduled the exams for February 23, 2024.

According to the standard procedure, there should be at least 90 days between the prelims and mains examination dates. However, this time, only 60 days were given, leaving many Group-2 candidates concerned about inadequate preparation time. Consequently, they approached APPSC Chairperson Anuradha, requesting a date change to allow for additional preparation

Additionally, Uttarandhra MLC Vepada Chiranjeevi Rao, on behalf of the Group-2 candidates, also met with the APPSC Chairperson, advocating for a 30-day extension. Several other MLCs and public representatives made similar appeals to APPSC.

Crore for Red Canal Modernization TPN, Amaravati: Tadepalligudem MLA and Government Whip Bolishetti Srinivas raised a pressing concern regarding the Red Canal in the Andhra Pradesh Assembly, advocating for an allocation of Rs. 100 crore to strengthen embankments and

modernize the canal.

During his address, Srinivas highlighted the challenges faced by farmers in Tadepalligudem, Tanuku, and Nidadavolu constituencies, where thousands of acres are affected by annual flooding from the Red Canal. This flooding has led to severe crop damage and financial strain on local farmers, who continue to suffer from recurrent losses.

Srinivas emphasized that modernization of the Red Canal has been a necessity since 2019, as the canal stretches approximately 185 kilometers, originating from Khammam district in Telangana and running through to Bhimavaram in Andhra Pradesh. The canal has become prone to overflowing, and without immediate infrastructure improvements, the issue will persist, he warned.

He called on the government to take decisive action to ensure a permanent solution to the flooding, which would protect the livelihoods of farmers in the region and mitigate the annual agricultural disruptions caused by the Red Canal's overflow.



Crackdown on Ration Mafia 1010 Cases Registered, 60,000 Metric

Tons of Rice Seized

TPN, Amaravati: The Andhra Pradesh government has intensified its efforts against illegal smuggling of subsidized ration rice, with 1010 cases registered and over 60,000 metric tons of rice seized since the coalition government came to power. State Minister for Food, Civil Supplies, and Consumer Affairs, Nadendla Manohar, addressed the Legislative Council on Wednesday, highlighting the government's commitment to eradicating the so-called "ration mafia"

operating in the state.

Minister Manohar explained that, despite the central and state governments providing ration rice at subsidized rates to support poor families, some operators, including certain MDUs (Mandals Distribution Units), have been found illegally diverting PDS (Public Distribution System) rice for profit. He warned that arrests of those involved in these illegal activities are inevitable following thorough investigations. The minister added that criminal cases have already been filed against 13 rice mills in Kakinada, which have been implicated in smuggling activities.

To prevent further illegal exports, the government has established checkposts across key areas, and port authorities have been instructed to permit rice exports only upon receipt of NOC (No Objection Certificates) from police, revenue, and civil supply officers, coordinated by the Joint Collector.

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: TDP MLA Raghuramakrishna Raju has been confirmed as the Deputy Speaker of the AP Assembly. Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu finalized Raju's name on Tuesday after considering several leaders and ultimately favoring Raghuramakrishna Raju (RRR).

The notification for the Deputy Speaker position will be issued on Wednesday and Thursday. If no other nominations are submitted, the alliance MLAs are expected to elect Raju as Deputy Speaker unanimously, making his election almost a for-

Raghuramakrishna Raju recently won as an MLA from the West Godavari district in the latest elections. In the 2019 elections, he contested and won the Narasapuram Lok Sabha seat on behalf of the YSR Congress Party (YCP). However, Raju resigned from the YCP and joined TDP prior to the 2024 elections.





Revanth Reddy: Competing with Global Cities, Not Andhra

- Telangana CM aims to compete with New York and Seoul, not just neighboring states

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, in a recent interview with The Indian Express, expressed his vision for Telangana and Hyderabad's development. He stated that his competition is not with neighboring states like Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, or Gujarat, but with prominent global cities such as New York and Seoul. "The world is now a small village, and Hyderabad should compete on the world stage, not just within India," he remarked, indicating his ambition for the city.

Reflecting on investment strategies, Reddy mentioned that Telangana welcomes investments from entities like Adani, provided they contribute to the state's growth without diverting resources from other regions. "The difference between Congress and BJP," he said, "is that we don't believe in taking from others just to give to one person."

He also highlighted the importance of Telangana's role in the national economy, criticizing the allocation of funds that disadvantages states like Telangana. According to him, only 40 paise out of every rupee Telangana sends to the Centre returns to the state, while a disproportionate amount goes to states like



Bihar and Uttar Pradesh. He voiced concern over this imbalance, noting, "Funds should reflect contribution, not just population."

In his response to a question about "North-South" relations, Reddy challenged this phrasing, suggesting it reflects an inherent bias and proposed saying "South-North" as well. He emphasized that states like Telangana are integral to achieving a \$5 trillion economy, urging for more equitable treatment to support national growth.

CBN Named Most Powerful Chief Minister by India Today



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a recent article, national media outlet India Today ranked Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu as India's most powerful Chief Minister and placed him fifth among the top ten influential leaders in the country. Positioned just below top national figures—Prime Minister Narendra Modi, RSS Chief Mohan Bhagwat, Home Minister Amit Shah, and Congress leader Rahul Gandhi—Chandrababu's influence is highlighted as central to current Indian politics.

Among state leaders, India Today ranks Chandrababu above Chief Ministers Nitish Kumar (Bihar), Yogi Adityanath (Uttar Pradesh), MK Stalin (Tamil Nadu), and Mamata Banerjee (West Bengal), as well as Samajwadi Party leader Akhilesh Yadav.

Describing Chandrababu's recent political resurgence, *India Today* likened his journey to a Hollywood thriller, noting his rebirth "like a phoenix" from a politically challenging period to reclaim power. His alliance with Jana Sena and BJP is credited with pulling the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) from decline to victory, earning him a central role in the NDA coalition.

The article further highlights Chandrababu's ambitions for Andhra Pradesh, particularly his Vision-2047 document, which aims to achieve a 15% growth rate and boost the state economy to \$2.4 trillion, with a per capita income target of \$43,000 by 2047. His longstanding goal of establishing Amaravati as the state's capital is also discussed, noting his plans to develop



Andhra Pradesh as a "Golden Andhra."

In his political career, Chandrababu is recognized for fostering corporate partnerships, such as the establishment of the Indian School of Business (ISB) during his second term as Chief Minister of the united Andhra Pradesh. As the most senior CM in India, *India Today* describes him as a key player in the nation's governance, potentially influencing the direction of the NDA government at the center.

Inturi Ravikiran's Wife Sujana Meets Former CM Jagan

- Sujana accuses police of harassing her husband
- Claims nine cases have been filed in various locations

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Sujana, the wife of YSRCP social media activist Inturi Ravikiran, who is currently in police custody, met with former CM YS Jaganmohan Reddy on Tuesday. Ravikiran had previously posted controversial content against opposition leaders on social media during the previous government's regime, leading to his recent legal troubles. Sujana visited Jagan at his office in Tadepalli, where she alleged that police are subjecting her husband

to continuous harassment by moving him from an al. She expressed frustration that each time her station to station, supposedly under instructions from senior officials. She claimed that her husband is often taken without being informed of his destination.

Sujana revealed that nine cases have been filed against her husband in locations such as Gudivada, Arandalpet, and Visakhapatnam. Ambati Rambabu's Tip-Off Leads to Arrest of Party's SM Activist

TPN, Guntur: In an unexpected turn of events, YCP leader Ambati Rambabu inadvertently facilitated the arrest of Rajasekhar Reddy, a social media activist for the YSR Congress Party, after openly challenging the police. Rajasekhar Reddy, a resident of Nakarikallu in Palnadu district, had posted inappropriate content about Home Minister Anita, prompting the police to initiate a case in Nuziveedu.

The authorities had been actively searching for Rajasekhar, visiting his residence in Nakarikallu with no success. On Tuesday, Ambati Rambabu, appearing before the media, boldly announced Rajasekhar's whereabouts and even encouraged the police to apprehend him if they could. The statement led the Nuziveedu police to act swiftly, arresting Rajasekhar, who was reportedly staying at Ambati's Guntur residence.

Notably, neither Ambati Rambabu nor his supporters attempted to intervene or obstruct the arrest, raising questions about the intent behind the public disclosure of Rajasekhar's location. Observers speculated that the incident may have



stemmed from Rambabu's dissatisfaction with Rajasekhar's stay at his residence, leading to the public "challenge" that ultimately facilitated the activist's arrest.

The episode comes as a twist amid the YSRCP's efforts to support its social media network, leaving many within the party's circles both surprised and speculating about the Ramababu's unconventional approach.

Key Leader Clears Air on **Leaving YCP**

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Jagan Mohan Reddy's YSR Congress Party (YCP) swept the 2019 elections with a massive majority, earning praises from party leaders who declared Jagan as an exceptional leader. However, following YCP's defeat in the 2024 elections, many of these leaders have changed their tune,

attributing the loss to Jagan. As a result, numerous senior leaders are now leaving the party, including some who were previously strong supporters of Jagan.

Prominent leaders like Kilaru Roshaiah, Maddali Giri, Sidda Raghavrao, former minister Alla Nani, Balineni Srinivasa Reddy, and Samineni Udayabhanu have recently announced their resignations from YCP. Additionally, three MLCs and three Rajya Sabha members, including close allies of Jagan, have also departed. Among them are leaders who were known to have a close rapport with Jagan, such as Alla Nani and Balineni, both of whom previously held ministerial posts under his leadership.

In the latest development, Rajya Sabha members like Beda Mastar Rao, Mopidevi Venkata Ramana, and R Krishnaiah have resigned from both the party and their posts. Additionally,



MLC Pandila Ravindra Babu was rumored to be considering an exit from YCP. However, Ravindra Babu has strongly refuted these claims, dismissing them as baseless rumors. He urged the public and YCP supporters not to believe such false news, affirming, "My journey is with Jagan."

Speaking on the matter, Ravindra Babu praised Jagan's efforts, stating that under Jagan's leadership, Andhra Pradesh witnessed unprecedented development, particularly in empowering Dalits and treating all castes equally. TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh Assembly sessions commenced on the 11th of this month, with the coalition government presenting the state budget on the same day. State Finance Minister Payyavula Keshav introduced a budget totaling Rs. 2.94 lakh crore, with capital expenditure of Rs. 32,712 crore and a fiscal deficit of Rs. 68,743 crore. Recently, YCP leader Jagan Mohan Reddy voiced strong criticism regarding this budget.

Jagan remarked, "If you examine these budget documents, you'll understand that Chandrababu is nothing more than a drama artist. It has been months since he came to power, and now that the budget has been introduced, it shows how the delays were merely a cover-up for fraud."

Reflecting on past events, Jagan said that during the previous government's tenure,

they falsely claimed that AP was more indebted than Sri Lanka, spreading this narrative in conversations with Chandrababu's close associates. "Before the election, they said the state's debt was Rs. 14 lakh crore, and when Chandrababu came to power, he repeated the same lies to the Governor."

"When we came to power in 2019, the state debt was Rs. 3.13 lakh crore. By the

time we stepped down in 2024, the debt was Rs. 6.46 lakh crore. If the debt grew by 19 percent during Chandrababu's previous tenure, it increased by only 15 percent under ours. So tell me, who deserves the title of 'Appu Ratna' (Master of Debt)? Who truly practiced financial discipline?" Jagan asked.

Jagan continued, suggesting that Chandrababu is ignoring the "Super Six" promises he made. "He pledged to lower electricity charges if he came to power, but now, in just six months, he has burdened the state with Rs. 17,000 crore in electricity bills."

In response to the coalition's claims about attracting major projects, Jagan pointed out that Reliance, Ambani, and Adani were drawn to Andhra Pradesh during his government's term. "Yet, the alliance leaders are trying to take credit for all these projects," he remarked, dismissing their claims.

But, When questioned about his sister Sharmila's comments on his absence from the assembly, YS Jagan brushed it off, telling the journalist, "Not now."

You Will Soon Have to Pay a Fee to Visit Beaches in AP

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In Andhra Pradesh, with nearly a thousand kilometers of coastline, both locals and tourists from other states and countries have enjoyed free access to beaches until now. However, this may soon change, as the government is preparing to introduce entry charges for beach access. Consequently, those wishing to visit the beaches

might need to budget for these new fees.

The government has decided to collect user charges from visitors at five selected beaches in AP starting from January 1. These include Suryalanka Beach in Bapatla, Ramayapatnam Beach in Prakasam District, Maipadu Beach in Nellore District, Kakinada Beach in Kakina-



da District, and Rushikonda Beach in Vizag. Tourists who have enjoyed free access to these beaches for years will now need to pay a user fee to enter.

In its plan to develop and enhance the state's beaches, the government will initiate beautification efforts in a phased manner. These five beaches will be prioritized,

with improvement works including beautification and facility upgrades expected to be completed by December 31. The entry fee will be introduced starting January 1. Tourism Minister Kandula Durgesh recently stated that the fees collected will be reinvested into the respective beach. The charges are expected to range between Rs. 15 to Rs. 20 per visitor.

The Parallels Between Ancient Rome and Modern America: Decline of Empire?



The recent election of Donald Trump as President of the United States sparked a flurry of international congratulations, underscoring the still-dominant role of America in global affairs. Even as America's influence appears to be in gradual decline, it remains the preeminent superpower, echoing the imperial stature once held by ancient Rome.

The parallels between Washington DC and ancient Rome are striking. Much like the grandeur of Rome, Washington has become a symbol of authority and power, drawing world leaders to pay homage and secure favor. In ancient Rome, emissaries traveled from far-flung corners of the empire—Britannia, Egypt, and beyond—to bask in the emperor's glory. Today, diplomats and heads of state converge in Washington, seeking to align themselves with America's power.

The city's architecture further amplifies this imperial imagery. Several federal buildings in DC, including the US Capitol and the Supreme Court, were designed with heavy influences from Roman architecture. This was no accident. Thomas Jefferson, inspired by the ideals of the Roman Republic, deliberately infused DC's design with neoclassical elements to represent democracy, liberty, and grandeur—principles that formed the foundation of the United States. These buildings not only reflect the aesthetic legacy of Rome but also the republican ideals of civic virtue, law, and justice.

Roman emperors were known for their ability

to wield power across vast territories, and their influence is mirrored in the presidencies of the United States. For instance, Augustus, Rome's first emperor, who established order and stability across the empire, has a counterpart in George Washington, whose leadership helped solidify the United States' foundation as a powerful and stable nation. Similarly, emperors like Trajan, who expanded Rome's territory and initiated monumental infrastructure projects, have echoes in American leaders like Theodore Roosevelt, who oversaw the expansion of American influence and initiated major national reforms. Perhaps the most striking comparison is between Constantine the Great and Abraham Lincoln, both of whom unified their deeply divided realms, transforming their nations' moral and cultural landscapes.

Donald Trump, the 45th President, shares intriguing similarities with two notorious Roman emperors: Nero and Caligula. Like Nero, Trump's reign was marked by controversies, self-promotion, and a fiercely loyal base. Nero's scandals and flamboyant style bear a resemblance to Trump's own approach to leadership, characterized by constant media attention and polarizing rhetoric. On the other hand, Trump shares some traits with the lesser-known Caligula, whose audacious decisions and disregard for Roman traditions were similarly disruptive. Both Trump and Caligula defied conventions, challenging the established political elite and often bypassing traditional norms for a more personal and controversial form of leadership.


Maharaja Ranjit Singh: The **Lion of Punjab Who United** the Sikh Empire

In 1799, Maharaja Ranjit Singh achieved a remarkable feat, unifying the scattered territories of Punjab to form a powerful Sikh empire with Lahore as its capital. Known as the "Lion of Punjab" (Sher-e-Punjab), Ranjit Singh emerged as a strong ruler who transformed the political landscape of North India, thwarting Afghan invasions and bringing stability to a region previously divided into autonomous territories, or Misls.

Under Ranjit Singh's leadership, the Sikh Empire spread over vast regions, incorporating former Mughal provinces such as Lahore and Multan, parts of Kabul, and even the entire Peshawar region. The empire's borders extended to Ladakh in the northeast, the Khyber Pass in the northwest, and Panjnad in the south, where Punjab's five rivers converge into the Indus. During his reign, Punjab became a land not just of five, but six rivers, with the Indus now flowing through his territory.

One of Ranjit Singh's most accomplished generals, Zorawar Singh from Jammu, played a crucial role in expanding the empire's borders by conquering Ladakh in Ranjit Singh's name. This conquest highlighted the strategic foresight and ambition of the maharaja, who sought not only to consolidate but also to extend his rule.

Ranjit Singh ruled as a faithful Sikh, yet his approach to governance was highly inclusive. He was deeply respectful of the Hindu and Muslim communities within his emgious practices. He actively restored and supported Sikh, Hindu, and Muslim places of worship. Most notably, he undertook the grand reconstruction of the Harmandir Sahib, also known as the





Golden Temple, at Amritsar. In 1809, he ordered its marble reconstruction and later, in 1830, donated gold to gild the The legacy of Maharaja Ranstructure, giving it the iconic look it retains to this day.

His generosity extended beyond Sikhism. Ranjit Singh also donated a tonne of gold to the Hindu Kashi Vishwanath temple in Varanasi, an act that demonstrated his respect for Hinduism. In a pioneering move, he hired European military experts, specifically French and Italian officers who had served under Napoleon Bonaparte. Among these were Generals Jean-Baptiste Ventura and Jean-Francois Allard, each earning a significant annual salary of around Rs. 30,000. They were later joined by other European officers, including Auguste Court and Paolo Avitabile, forming a specialized brigade known as the Fauj-i-Khas, or "special army."

These foreign officers adapted to life in India, taking Indian wives and immersing themselves in local customs and culture. They even employed Indian artists, becoming prominent figures in Lahore's court and symbolizing a rare fusion of Eastern and Western military and cultural practices.

jit Singh endures not only in India but also in the West. In 2016, the French town of St. Tropez honored him by unveiling a bronze statue of the maharaja. The statue stands as a tribute to his unique rule, marked by strategic prowess, respect for cultural diversity, and an innovative approach to military modmonious blend of power, toltinues to inspire admiration worldwide.

Conversely, Iran is a vital energy partner, and the two nations also share

concerns about terrorism from Pakistan and Afghanistan. Iran's Chabahar port, developed in partnership with India, provides New Delhi with direct access to Afghanistan and Central Asia, bypassing Pakistan—a crucial strategic advantage. Despite U.S. sanctions on Iran, India has continued to engage with Tehran, recognizing Iran's importance for regional connectivity and security.

The Israel-Palestine Conflict and Regional Peace

India's approach to the Israel-Palestine conflict is rooted in a commitment to peace and stability in West Asia. Unlike many West Asian countries, which have differing stances on groups like Hamas and Hezbollah, India supports a twostate solution. This vision aligns with that of the United States and European nations, aiming for a peaceful coexistence between Israel and Palestine. As violence flares, India remains diplomatic, promoting peace without alienating any side.

Security Threats and the Need for Stability

The security landscape of West Asia directly impacts India's strategic interests. The recent rise of militant activities, including drone strikes and missile attacks between Israel and Iran, threatens India's investments in the region and the safety of its diaspora. The presence of extremist groups and regional rivalries further complicate India's engagement with West Asia, demanding a cautious approach to avoid entanglement in conflicts while securing its interests.

West Asia's volatility poses a significant challenge for India's diplomacy. Escalating conflicts could jeopardize Indian investments, endanger the large Indian diaspora, and disrupt energy supplies. India's nuanced approach—engaging with Israel, Iran, and major Arab nations while remaining neutral—aims to preserve goodwill across the board. This strategy allows India to adapt to the region's shifting dynamics, supporting stability and growth at home.

India's relationship with West Asia demonstrates its ambition to be a stabilizing force in a region vital for its economy and security. As it balances its ties with various nations, India's strategic diplomacy aims to maintain stability, protect its energy supply, and safeguard the welfare of millions of Indians. BJP won't allow anyone to play with your 'Maati, Roti, Beti': PM Modi in Jharkhand

Sarath: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday accused the ruling JMM-Congress-RJD government in Jharkhand of enabling illegal Bangladeshi infiltration, claiming a conspiracy was underway to alter the state's demographic makeup and dilute its tribal identity. Addressing rallies in Sarath and Godda ahead of the second phase of Jharkhand Assembly elections, Modi warned that the tribal population, especially in the Santhal Parganas region, was being reduced due to "infiltrators" being given legitimacy.

Modi stressed the importance of preserving the tribal identity of Jharkhand, saying, "You love your identity as a Jharkhandi, but what will happen if that identity is lost? The statistics show that the tribal population in Santhal Parganas has halved. Your 'Jal, Jungle, Jameen' (water, forest, land) is being taken away. We need to save both the tribals and Jharkhand itself."

The Prime Minister further claimed that the state government was involved in "wrong decisions" that were allowing infiltrators to settle in Jharkhand, saying that documents



were being fabricated overnight to facilitate this. He alleged that tribal girls were being exploited under the guise of marriage, and that the government was allowing outsiders to take over land and livelihood. "I assure you, the BJP-NDA government will not allow anyone to play with your Maati (land), Roti (livelihood), and Beti (daughter)," Modi asserted.

This statement aligns with the BJP's ongoing campaign, which has made the issue of Bangladeshi infiltration and its impact on the tribal community a central focus in the elections. The party has accused the ruling government of neglecting the concerns of the local population while facilitating demographic changes.



Vote to protect rights, strengthen Constitution: Rahul to Jharkhand voters

Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, on Wednesday appealed to the voters of Jharkhand to cast their ballots in favor of the I.N.D.I.A. bloc, emphasizing that their vote would not only strengthen the Constitution and democracy but also bring prosperity through a series of guarantees aimed at improving the lives of the people.

He added that a vote for the opposition coalition would usher in a new era of prosperity for the people of Jharkhand and India as a whole.

Gandhi highlighted the seven key guarantees that the I.N.D.I.A. bloc promises to deliver, which include securing jobs for the youth, better healthcare for all, affordable education, protection for farmers, strengthening social welfare

schemes, providing financial support to small businesses, and ensuring women's safety and empowerment.

He also criticized the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) for what he termed as a "divisive agenda" that has only served to undermine the country's democratic institutions. "The BJP has been using power to divide the people of India, but the I.N.D.I.A. alliance believes in unity and working together for the welfare of all," Gandhi remarked.

Trump Sets 'Existential' Battle **Against China With Cabinet Picks**

Donald Trump is preparing for a more confrontational approach toward China with the appointment of two hawkish Florida politicians—Senator Marco Rubio and Congressman Mike Waltz—who are expected to play key roles in his administration's foreign policy. As Trump positions himself for a potential existential battle against China, his appointments signal a shift away from the more diplomatic tone of the Biden administration.

Rubio, rumored to be tapped as secretary of state, and Waltz, who could be appointed national security advisor, are staunch advocates for a more aggressive US stance on China. Rubio, in particular, has repeatedly warned that the United States is already in a "broad global conflict" with China, which, he claims, seeks not only to become the world's most powerful nation but also to "reorient the world." His views contrast sharply with President Joe Biden's more dialogue-focused approach, which has emphasized cooperation with China on issues like climate change while ramping up competition in areas like trade.

Biden's administration has acknowledged China as the US's top long-term adversary and imposed sanctions on Beijing, but tensions have cooled recently, with Secretary of State Antony Blinken prioritizing diplomatic engagement to avoid accidental conflict. By contrast, Rubio and Waltz view China's rise as an existential threat to the US, aligning with a more hawkish faction within the Republican Party that sees China's ambitions as a direct challenge to American global leadership.

Iran's government fears its people more than Israel: Netanyahu

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu sent a direct message to the people of Iran on Tuesday, accusing the regime of Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei of fearing its own citizens more than Israel. Netanyahu's comments were made amid rising tensions between the two nations, as Iran faces both internal unrest and external pressure over its nuclear program and regional influence.

In his message, Netanyahu emphasized the Iranian government's perceived insecurity, claiming that it spends significant time and resources on suppressing its people rather than addressing external threats, including Israel. "That's why they spend so much time and money," Netanyahu said, referring to the regime's efforts to control domestic dissent, including the use of violent crackdowns on protests and opposition movements.



The message came in the wake of a series of protests across Iran, sparked by the death of 22-year-old Mahsa Amini in September 2022 while in police custody, which led to widespread demands for greater political freedoms and women's rights. The regime's harsh response to these protests, including mass arrests and violence, has drawn international condemnation.

Netanyahu, who has been a vocal critic of Iran's nuclear ambitions, reiterated Israel's stance on Iran's nuclear program, which Israel believes is a threat to its existence. He also warned the Iranian leadership that their focus on internal repression could ultimately undermine the regime's hold on power, as the Iranian people continued to demand greater freedoms and reforms.



Germany to Hold Early Elections After Coalition Collapse

Germany will hold early elections on February 23 following the breakdown of the coalition government led by Chancellor Olaf Scholz. The decision was confirmed after an agreement between Scholz's Social Democratic Party (SPD) and the opposition Christian Democratic Union (CDU/CSU), according to DW Politics.

The crisis began last week when Scholz dismissed Finance Minister Christian Lindner, the leader of the pro-business Free Democratic Party (FDP). This dramatic move led to the FDP's immediate exit from the coalition, leaving Scholz's SPD and



the Greens without a majority in the Bundestag. The departure The collapse of the coalition of the FDP left a power vacuum that ultimately led to the collapse of the governing alliance.

Sharif highlighted the disproportionate impact that climate change has on developing nations, which, despite contributing the least to global emissions, face the brunt of the consequences, including extreme weather events, flooding, and droughts. 

Market Rout Continues: Indices Plunge as Investor Confidence Wanes



Indian stock market opens in red amid consolidation phase



The Indian stock market opened in the negative on Wednesday, with broad-based selling witnessed across most sectors, except for private banks, in early trade. The benchmark indices, Sensex and Nifty, saw substantial losses, reflecting the bearish sentiment in the market.

At 9:30 AM, the BSE Sensex was trading at 78,260, down by 414 points, while the NSE Nifty stood at 23,706, having dropped 167 points. The market trend remained firmly negative with significant declines across various indices. On the National Stock Exchange (NSE), only 335 stocks were in the green, while a massive 1,948 stocks were in the red.

The Nifty Bank index, however, was a rare outperformer, trading at 51,194.40, up by 36.60 points or 0.07%. Meanwhile, the Nifty Midcap 100 index was down by 1.60%, trading at 54,375.30, and the Nifty Smallcap 100 index saw a steep fall of 2.07%, hovering at 17,618.75.

Among the top losers in the Sensex pack were major stocks such as Mahindra & Mahindra (M&M), Tata Steel, Maruti Suzuki, Sun lies on the critical support zone Pharma, Reliance Industries, Nes-

tle India, JSW Steel, and Power Grid. On the other hand, the top gainers included NTPC, Bharti Airtel, Hindustan Unilever, Asian Paints, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Axis Bank, and HDFC.

Market experts noted that there has been a notable disparity in market performance globally this year. The US market, led by the S&P 500, has posted a strong year-todate (YTD) return of 26.17%, while India's Nifty has underperformed with just 9.85% YTD returns. The Euro Zone has seen modest returns with the Stoxx 50 index delivering only 5.14% YTD growth.

In the broader Asian markets, most indices were trading in the red, except for Jakarta and Bangkok. US stock markets had also closed lower on the previous trading day. Foreign institutional investors (FIIs) continued to sell equities, offloading Rs 3,024 crore on November 12, while domestic institutional investors (DIIs) bought equities worth Rs 1,854 crore.

Sebi proposes accountability for AI use by market infra institutions

 $R^{ ext{egulator}}$ Sebi on Wednesday proposed holding market infrastructure institutions and intermediaries accountable for any consequences arising from their use of artificial intelligence (AI) tools in operations or client services.

includes ensuring This privacy, security, and integrity, particularly when handling sensitive investor information.

Additionally, the entity should also be accountable for any actions taken based on AI outputs, Sebi said in its consultation paper.

AI is being increasingly used in investor services and compliance operations. The usage is enabling stakeholders in making informed decisions and thus playing increasingly significant role in market analysis, stock selection, investment strategies and in building a portfolio in their invested securities.

However, while recognising the need for intermediaries to embrace such latest techniques and AI tools, it is equally important to ensure the protection of investors with the usage of such tool, Sebi said.

Recognising both the advantages of AI — like enhanced efficiency, accuracy, and risk management — and the need for investor protection, Sebi has earlier mandated reporting on AI usage



for entities like stock brokers, depositories, and mutual funds.

Now, the regulator, in its consultation paper, has proposed that all Sebi regulated entities that use AI in any capacity must be fully responsible for all outcomes of its AI use, regardless of the extent of their AI usage.


"Every person regulated by Sebi that uses such artificial intelligence tools and techniques while conducting its activities in the securities markets and for servicing its clients, regardless of the scope and size of adoption of such tools, shall apart from complying with all applicable laws in force be solely responsible for all the consequences of such use including ensuring the privacy, security and integrity of the investors' and stakeholders' data especially the data maintained by it in a fiduciary capacity, throughout the processes involved.

"...and shall be responsible if the output arising from the usage of such tools and techniques is relied upon or dealt with," Sebi said.


Robot performs surgery with the skill of a human doctor



Tn a groundbreaking development for the fu-Lture of robot-assisted surgery, researchers at Johns Hopkins University (JHU) have successfully trained a robot to perform complex medical procedures by simply watching videos of human doctors in action. This innovative approach, called "imitation learning," marks a significant step toward achieving true autonomy in robotic surgery.

Traditionally, programming a robot for surgical tasks has required meticulous, step-by-step instructions, with each movement of the procedure pre-programmed by human engineers. However, the JHU team has bypassed this requirement by allowing the robot to learn by observing how experienced surgeons perform tasks, essentially mimicking their actions. This method has allowed the robot to perform surgeries with precision comparable to that of human doctors, offering a glimpse into the future of surgical automation.

Imitation learning, as explained by the researchers, involves training a machine to replicate observed behavior. In this case, the robot learned how to execute intricate surgical maneuvers




simply by analyzing video footage of real-life surgeries. The process eliminates the need for detailed programming of every action, making it a more efficient and scalable approach to robotic surgery.

The breakthrough could pave the way for robots to perform complex medical procedures with minimal human oversight, opening up possibilities for fully autonomous surgeries. While the robot's ability to carry out such tasks with a high degree of accuracy is a significant achievement, researchers acknowledge that further advancements are necessary before such systems can be trusted for use in real-world surgeries.

The JHU researchers presented their findings at the prestigious Conference on Robot Learning in Munich, Germany, where experts in robotics and machine learning gathered to discuss the latest advancements in the field. This research is expected to accelerate the development of robotic surgery systems that can reduce the need for human intervention, enhance precision, and potentially make surgeries safer and more accessible in the future.

Despite their victories, India has been somewhat wasteful in converting scoring opportunities. In their 4-0 win against Malaysia, and a narrow 3-2 victory over South Korea, India created numerous chances but failed to score as many goals as they would have liked. After Tuesday's win over South Korea, head coach Harendra Singh admitted that his team had been guilty of rushing their plays and not always making the right decisions inside the opposition's circle.

"We could have scored more goals. We rushed our choices and didn't always look for the right options," said Harendra, adding that the team would analyze match footage and work on improving their decision-making in the final third.

Another area of concern for the team has been their penalty corner conversion rate. India earned 11 penalty corners against Malaysia but converted only three, all through indirect attempts. Against South Korea, India was awarded eight penalty corners but failed to capitalize on any of them. Improving their set-piece efficiency will be a priority for the team moving forward.

Despite these areas for improvement, India has seen strong performances from forwards Sangita Kumari and Deepika, both of whom have scored three goals each. Sangita, in particular, has been a standout player with her excellent stick work and lively attacking play. However, players like Sharmila Devi, Preeti Dubey, and Beauty Dung Dung will need to take on more responsibility in the attacking third.

India's captain, Salima Tete, and vice-captain Navneet Kaur will also need to improve their midfield play to ensure better ball distribution and support for the forwards.




