

Chandrababu Carries His Brother's Bier



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: AP Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu's brother, Nara Rammurthy Naidu, who passed away yesterday in a private hospital in Hyderabad due to a serious illness, was solemnly cremated today in his native village, Naravaripalle. CM Chandrababu, his son and Minister Nara Lokesh, along with Rammurthy Naidu's son Nara Rohit and other family members, participated in the last rites.

Several ministers and VIPs visited Naravaripalle to pay their respects to Rammurthy Naidu's mortal remains, which were brought from Hyderabad earlier in the day. His body was then taken on its final journey to the ancestral cremation site in Naravaripalle. Along with Chandrababu, Lokesh, Rohit, and many members of the Nara and Nandamuri families participated in the procession.

On this solemn occasion, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu symbolically fulfilled his duty to his younger brother by carrying his bier. Minister Nara Lokesh, Nara Rohit, and Chandragiri MLA Pulivarthi Nani also joined him in carrying the bier. Rammurthy Naidu had a significant political journey, having entered politics with the support of his elder brother Chandrababu Naidu, despite being a political adversary in their early days. Chandrababu had once ensured that Rammurthy Naidu secured a ticket and won as an MLA. Can YSRCP MLAs Face **Disqualification Over Assembly Boycott?**



TPN, Amaravati: The YSR Congress Party (YSRCP), led by YS Jagan Mohan Reddy, has boycotted the Andhra Pradesh Assembly, citing the denial of Leader of the Opposition status as their primary grievance. This has sparked a political debate about the possible consequences of such a boycott, with Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu remarking, "Law will do its work."

The boycott raises questions about whether YSRCP MLAs could face disqualification for non-attendance. According to Article 190(4) of the Indian Constitution, a legislator can be disqualified if they are absent from all sessions of the legislature for 60 days without proper permission. However, this provision includes several caveats.

The 60-day rule only applies to active session days, excluding periods when the house is prorogued or adjourned for more than four consecutive days. This complicates the situation, given the irregular frequency of Assembly sessions. Typically, state legislatures convene for an average of 100 days over a five-year term. In Andhra Pradesh, the Assembly has only functioned for 71 days since 2019, primarily due to disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Given these circumstances, reaching the 60-day threshold for disqualification could take years.





First Case On **Former Minister** Kodali Nani

TPN, Vizag: YSRCP leader and former minister Kodali Nani is in the spotlight for the wrong reasons, as a legal case has been filed against him in Visakhapatnam. Andhra University law student Satyala Anjana Priya lodged a complaint accusing Nani of using inappropriate and abusive language during press releases and assembly sessions over the five-year tenure of the YSRCP government.

According to the complaint, Kodali Nani's remarks targeted TDP leader and current Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu, as well as his son, Minister Nara Lokesh. Anjana Priya alleged that these comments were not only offensive but also damaging to their personal and family reputations. She further stated that, as a woman and a law student, she found the language deeply troubling and harmful to societal norms.

The complainant emphasized that Nani's alleged remarks contributed to body shaming and made baseless accusations, creating a toxic environment that could foster disrespect and incite negative behavior.

Good News for Farmers, AP Govt Launches WhatsApp Service to Sell Grain TPN, Amaravati: In a farm-



State Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar, speaking at a press conference in Amaravati on Sunday, announced that the government has made grain procurement easier by enabling services through WhatsApp. Farmers can now send a message to the dedicated number 73373-59375, which is supported by a special artificial intelligence-powered voice system, to initiate the grain selling process.

How It Works

To access the service, a farmer must first register with their Aadhaar Farmer Support number. Following verification, the farmer's name will be confirmed, This initiative is part of the coalition and they will be prompted to select a preferred purchasing center. Farmers will then need to provide the required details. Once completed, a coupon code will be sent to them via a special message. This coupon code can be used to sell grain at their chosen center on the designated date and time.

Minister Manohar emphasized that this service will save farmers With this WhatsApp-based service, valuable time, as they will no longer need to spend hours waiting at grain purchasing centers. "Our government is committed to imple-

menting the Ease of Doing Business service in a manner that benefits

our farmers directly," Manohar stated. He also assured farmers of the government's readiness to purchase their grain without delays.



Rumors of Pagan Propaganda in Tirumala: TTD Vigilance Steps In

Devasthanams (TTD) vigilance department has launched an investigation following rumors of pagan religious propaganda at Papa Vinashanam in Tirumala. Reports allege that over 20 individuals recorded reels with songs promoting their beliefs in the area, sparking a strong response from the community.

The claims suggest that these individuals engaged in religious activity with alleged cooperation from forest department officials a claim that the TTD is taking seriously as part of its inquiry. TTD officials are focusing on verifying whether the promotional reels were indeed created in the Tirumala vicinity or in a different location, amidst growing speculation and concerns.

International Solar Alliance Advocates for Mission LIFE to Achieve India's Climate Goals

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The International Solar Alliance (ISA) has endorsed India's Mission LIFE (Lifestyle for Environment) program, emphasizing its potential to propel the nation towards ambitious climate targets. The initiative aims to inspire individual and community action to protect the environment, aligning with India's commitments to reducing carbon emissions by one billion tons by 2030 and achieving net-zero emissions by 2070.

Dr. Ajay Mathur, Director General of ISA and a former member of the Prime Minister's Council on Climate Change, highlighted the need for an energy efficiency-driven strategy and active stakeholder engagement at the state level. Dr. Mathur underscored that public participation is crucial to the program's success. As part of the efforts to scale energy efficiency initiatives, the Media Advisor for Southern States/UTs of the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), Ministry of Power, met with Dr. Mathur in New Delhi. During the meeting, Dr. Mathur praised the significant achievements of BEE and Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL) in 2022-23, which resulted in energy savings of 306 billion kWh of electricity, 24.68 million tons of oil equivalent (MTOE) in thermal energy, and substantial economic benefits.

Under BEE's Perform, Achieve, and Trade (PAT) scheme, national energy savings of 8.67 MTOE and 31 million tons of CO2 reductions were achieved in Cycle I. These milestones were further amplified in Cycle II, with energy savings of 14.08 MTOE and a reduction of 68.43 million tons of CO2 emissions.

Andhra Pradesh: A Model for Energy Efficiency

States like Andhra Pradesh have been at the forefront of energy efficiency initiatives. BEE has set a target of 6.68 MTOE in energy savings for the state by 2030, contributing to India's roadmap of reducing projected carbon emissions by 887 million tons. Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has taken proactive steps to integrate energy efficiency into the state's development agenda.

Even if the YSRCP MLAs avoid attending the Assembly for extended periods, attending just one session would reset the clock. Additionally, extending Assembly sessions to expedite the process is a logistical challenge and a political gamble. Another layer of complexity arises with the potential by-elections if disqualifications were pursued. If the YSRCP loses these seats, it could further weaken their position. Even if they manage to retain all contested seats, they would still fall short of the numbers needed to reclaim

8 Sarpanchs Joined on TDP in West Godavari District



TPN, **Palakollu**: The wave of leaders and activists departing from the YSR Congress Party (YCP) to join the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) continues to grow. In a significant development, eight YCP sarpanchs from Palakollu mandal in West Godavari district have switched allegiance to the TDP, in the presence of Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu.

The exodus reflects growing dissatisfaction among local leaders, who claim they have been disrespected and marginalized under the leadership of Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy. The departing sarpanchs stated that despite their efforts to advance village development, their contributions were overlooked and their conditions worsened.

"Sarpanchs who prioritized village development have been left in severe financial distress. Many incurred substantial debts to fulfill promises made to their constituents and

complete development works," said one of the sarpanchs. "Due to lack of government funding for these projects, some were even driven to the tragic extreme of suicide."

The discontentment has simmered for years, with multiple protests staged by YCP sarpanchs to demand outstanding payments and funding for panchayats. However, their efforts yielded no results, deepening frustrations. As a result, they chose to leave the YCP, citing a lack of response and respect from the party's leadership.

This shift signals mounting pressure on Jagan's administration, with YCP vacancies increasing in several constituencies as more key leaders and activists defect to the TDP. TDP leaders see this as a reflection of their rising support among local representatives committed to community development and better governance.

CM Chandrababu Neglecting Rayalaseema Development - Ananta Venkatarami Reddy

TPN, Anantapuram: Ananta Venkatarami Reddy, President of the Anantapuram District YSR Congress Party, has accused Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu of failing to fulfill promises for Rayalaseema's development despite his repeated stints in power. Reddy expressed deep discontent, stating that Naidu, who claims to be a resident of Rayalaseema, has historically done little to uplift the region.

Reddy highlighted that Naidu's influence extended beyond political roadblocks. "During the YSR Congress Party's tenure, Chandrababu actively created hurdles that prevented Rayalaseema from being recognized as the legal capital," Reddy stated. He further decried recent developments regarding the relocation of the High Court and Lokayukta courts, calling it "a major betrayal" of the region's interests.

The issue of irrigation and water resource management was another area of contention. Reddy claimed that irrigation projects in Rayalaseema have been intentionally neglected and their capacities reduced. He also pointed out that the Handriniva project expansion has yet to receive full funding, undermining crucial water supply initiatives.

Reddy didn't stop at Naidu but also



turned his attention to the BJP. He alleged that while the party had once decided to establish a High Court in Kurnool, it is now "keeping silent" despite being in alliance, leaving Rayalaseema's aspirations unmet. "This silence is a betrayal of Rayalaseema's needs and rights," he declared.

The relocation of the cancer hospital to Tirupati further drew Reddy's ire. "When the central government allocated a cancer hospital to the coast, Chandrababu shifted it away from Rayalaseema to Tirupati," he alleged, highlighting the systemic neglect and perceived injustices faced by the region over the years.

Reddy called for immediate attention and a committed approach to right these wrongs, ensuring justice for Rayalaseema's long-standing demands.

Chandrababu Changes His Stand on Debts

Finance Ministers Lack Understanding of Calculations - Buggana

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former Finance Minister Buggana Rajendranath criticized Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu for altering his statements regarding the debts incurred during the YSRCP government in Andhra Pradesh. He pointed out that while Chandrababu earlier claimed the state's debt was ₹14 lakh crores, he is now alleging it to be ₹9.56 lakh crores. Buggana questioned why Chandrababu was now emphasizing the issue of debts in corporations.

Buggana accused Chandrababu of taking loans at high interest rates in the open market during his tenure and refuted claims that the YSRCP government had done the same. He also challenged whether former Finance Minister Yanamala Ramakrishna and

current Finance Minister Payyavula Buggana dismissed the opposition's Keshav truly understood financial calculations. He alleged that distributing to present accurate facts regarding the funds for welfare schemes through the state's financial management.

Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) system was being misrepresented as a scam by the opposition.

Regarding electricity "true-up" charges, Buggana stated that the opposition was spreading misinformation. He highlighted that during the TDP regime, ₹20,000 crores in true-up charges were levied over five years, compared to only ₹2,300 crores during the YSRCP's tenure in the same period. He further criticized the NDA government for imposing ₹6,770 crores in true-up charges within just five months.

YCP Mismanagement Has Destoryed the Kadapa Corporation - Madhavi Reddy

TPN, Kadapa: Telugu Desam Party (TDP) MLA and AP Legislative Assembly Whip, Madhavi Reddy, launched a scathing attack on the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP), alleging that the ruling party has crippled the Kadapa Municipal Corporation. Speaking at a media conference on Sunday, Reddy criticized the YSRCP for inefficiency and a lack of accountability in the Secretariat, which, she claimed, has resulted in stunted development for Kadapa district.

Highlighting the failure of past promises, Reddy pointed out that while a foundation stone was laid for the construction of a steel factory in Kadapa, no further progress was made. "The initiative remained limited to a symbolic stone-laying ceremony, with no tangible development afterward," she said. Reddy also called out the neglect in providing Teadco houses to eligible



beneficiaries, underscoring what she views as a lack of commitment to the people's welfare.

TDP Politburo Member Srinivasa Reddy echoed her concerns and criticized Jagan Mohan Reddy for stifling TDP leaders' participation in the Legislative Assembly. He assured the public that key issues would continue to be discussed in the Assembly and affirmed that the TDP's "Super Six" schemes would be implemented progressively. Reddy further highlighted the state's debt, accusing the YSRCP government of incurring a burden of ₹10 lakh crore and reaffirming the TDP's commitment to addressing opposition criticism.


A recent council meeting at the Kadapa Municipal Corporation turned tense when MLA Madhavi Reddy, accompanied by TDP supporters, expressed frustration over the seating arrangements. Reddy objected to being

relegated to sit among the corporators rather than beside the Mayor, which led to a heated exchange. Heavy police security was deployed to prevent clashes amid tensions between Reddy and YCP-aligned Mayor Suresh Babu.

The dispute underscores the growing friction between the TDP and YSRCP factions in Kadapa, with both parties vying for influence amid claims of neglect and political marginalization.

CPI Ramakrishna Slams Central Government and Demands Action on Key Issues

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: CPI State Secretary Ramakrishna has sharply criticized the Central Government, accusing it of extreme injustice toward Andhra Pradesh, particularly with regard to major irrigation projects. In a fiery statement, Ramakrishna claimed that the Polavaram project's benefits are at risk due to the Center's alleged attempts to lower its height, potentially saving ₹25,000 crores at the expense of Andhra Pradesh's inter-



Ramakrishna further criticized the handling of water allocations, pointing out that the Krishna Tribunal's first allocations ment campaigns starting in December.





The CPI leader also outlined a series of demands and actions. On November 18, petitions will be submitted to CM Chandrababu Naidu, urging him to allot 2-cent house plots in cities and 3-cent plots in villages. Ramakrishna expressed disappointment over proposed electricity tariff hikes, highlighting previous election promises not to burden the public. Protests to reduce electricity charges are planned from November 19 during the ongoing assembly meetings. Additionally, Ramakrishna criticized the Civil Supplies Minister for failing to control essential prices and warned of upcoming price move-

Another Case Registered Against Sri **Reddy Over Obscene Comments**

TPN, Guntur: A new case has been registered against actress Sri Reddy, following a complaint filed by former corporator Dasari Jyoti. The complaint alleges that Sri Reddy made obscene comments against TDP leaders Chandrababu Naidu, Pawan Kalyan, and their families. In her complaint, Dasari Jyoti requested that action be taken against the actress for her remarks, which have sparked controversy.

The Guntur police have taken up the matter, with investigations underway. This marks the latest in a series of cases being filed against Sri Reddy for making objectionable com-



ments about political figures, particularly those aligned with the TDP and the opposition YCP.

Previously, a case was filed against Sri Reddy in East Godavari district after she made inappropriate remarks about YCP leaders, including Home Minister Vangalapudi's comments on Anita. Hyderabad to Visakhapatnam in 4 Hours at 220 km/h

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The central government is planning to build a semi-highspeed rail corridor connecting Visakhapatnam to Shamshabad International Airport. The Railway Board is set to receive the preliminary engineering traffic survey report this month, which will provide clarity on the project's estimated cost. Following the Railway Board's approval of this report, a detailed project report (DPR) will be prepared through an in-depth survey. The initial estimated cost of the Visakhapatnam-Vijayawada-Shamshabad and Visakhapatnam-Vijayawada-Kurnool projects is projected to exceed ₹21,000 crores.

The number of stations along this corridor has been deliberately kept low to minimize travel time. The Visakhapatnam-Shamshabad route will feature six stations in Andhra Pradesh and six in Telangana. Additionally, the Kurnool-Visakhapatnam Semi High-Speed Corridor will connect at Suryapet. This route will have eight stations, with seven located in Telangana and Kurnool being the only station in Andhra Pradesh.

The longest distance between two stations will be 88 km, between Tuni and Rajahmundry, while the shortest will be 28 km, between Suryapet and Nakirekal.



The semi-high-speed corridor will by-pass Vijayawada National Highway from Shamshabad, passing through Gattuppal in the Munugodu constituency. The distance between Chautuppal and Gattuppal is 24 km, slightly away from the national highway. Due to Telangana being a smaller state, land acquisition presents a challenge. With high land prices along the national highway, the estimated project cost is expected to rise significantly.

To mitigate costs, the corridor is planned

to pass through Gattuppal to Chityal West, Nakirekal, and Suryapet. The Kurnool corridor will join at Suryapet. Once the survey is completed, a notification for land acquisition will be issued, and construction work will commence.

Traveling from Visakhapatnam to Shamshabad at a speed of 220 km/h is expected to reduce travel time to just four to fourand-a-half hours, significantly enhancing connectivity and boosting economic prospects in the region.

Railway Official Caught Taking Bribe

TPN, Vizag: Walther Division DRM Saurabh Prasad was caught red-handed by CBI officials while accepting a ₹25 lakh bribe from a contractor. The incident occurred at his residence in Mumbai, where he had instructed the contractor to deliver the bribe money while on vacation.

Saurabh Prasad, who is serving as the DRM of the Walther Railway Division in Visakhapatnam district, was apprehended by the CBI in a well-planned operation. The contractor traveled to Mumbai to deliver the bribe, only to have CBI officials catch Prasad in the act.

Following the incident, CBI teams from Delhi and Visakhapatnam conducted extensive searches at the DRM bungalow in Visakhapatnam from Saturday afternoon until late evening. During these raids, several important documents were reportedly seized.

Saurabh Prasad is currently under interrogation by the CBI as investigations into the case continue. The incident has brought significant attention to corruption within the railway division.

Case Registered Against Guntur Mayor and YCP Leader Manohar Naidu


Nobody should take Rahul Gandhi seriously: Nitin Gadkari

The Logan Act, a US law dating back to 1799, restricts private citizens from engaging in unauthorized negotiations with foreign governments. While the law is rarely invoked, it has been cited in situations where unofficial diplomatic discussions could potentially interfere with US foreign policy or undermine official negotiations.

Ishiba had been hoping to meet with Trump as part of his visit to Peru, where he was attending the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) summit. However, due to the legal limitations surrounding the pre-inauguration period, his request was declined.

The decision not to meet with the president-elect underscores the delicate nature of diplomatic interactions during the transition period between US ad-

According to a police statement, the bombs landed in the garden, but there were no injuries or damage. Neither Netanyahu nor his family members were present at the time of the attack, and the incident did not result in any immediate harm.

The attack occurred just a month after a drone strike targeted Netanyahu's residence, heightening concerns about the rising level of violence directed at prominent political figures in Israel. While the motives behind the flash bomb incident remain unclear, authorities are treating the event seriously and have launched an investigation.

Flash bombs, typically used to disorient or distract, are non-lethal devices that emit a bright flash and a loud sound, but they can cause significant shock and panic if deployed in populated areas. The leaders emphasized that nuclear weapons decisions should remain under human control and highlighted the importance of developing military AI responsibly.

A statement from the White House affirmed that both leaders acknowledged the need for caution when integrating AI into military systems, stressing the potential risks and the necessity of prudent development. "The two leaders affirmed the need to maintain human control over the decision to use nuclear weapons," the statement read. "They also stressed the importance of carefully considering the risks associated with military AI technology."

This agreement marks a significant step in the ongoing discussions between the US and China on nuclear arms and artificial intelligence—two areas where diplomatic progress has been slow and fraught with challenges. The US has been pushing China to engage in nuclear arms control talks, but progress has been limited, particularly after the brief resumption of talks in November, which saw little substantive movement.

The US Defense Department estimates that China currently has approximately 500 operational nuclear warheads, with projections indicating that number could surpass 1,000 by 2030. This rapid expansion of China's nuclear capabilities, including advanced systems like hypersonic glide vehicles and nuclear-armed submarines, has raised concerns in Washington and among US allies, especially given the backdrop of global nuclear arms competition.

While China's nuclear stockpile remains far smaller than those of Russia (1,710 warheads) and the US (1,770 warheads), its modernized nuclear arsenal and military advancements have sparked fears of an arms race. Nevertheless, China maintains a policy of "no first use" and advocates for minimal deterrence.

The Biden administration had previously updated its nuclear posture earlier this year, expressing concerns about China's growing nuclear capabilities. While the Biden-Xi agreement is a positive development, it remains to be seen whether it will lead to further talks or concrete actions to address these complex and interconnected challenges.



North Korea's 'Noise Bombing' Terrorizes South Korean Village Near DMZ

Residents of Dangsan, a small village near the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ) in South Korea, are enduring a new form of psychological warfare, as North Korea has ramped up its use of loudspeakers to broadcast disturbing sounds across the border. Since July, the loudspeakers have been blaring unsettling noises for up to 24 hours a day, replacing the traditional propaganda broadcasts with eerie sounds, from gonglike crashes to ghostly screams. Villagers have described the relentless barrage as "noise bombing," a constant, maddening assault that has disrupted their lives and made daily activities unbearable.

"It is driving us crazy," said one resident, speaking to *The New York Times*. "You can't sleep at night. It's bombing without shells." The constant noise, ranging from metallic grinding to howling wolves and artillery-like blasts, has caused widespread insomnia, headaches, and stress among the villagers, many of whom are elderly. Unlike the previous propaganda broadcasts, which included music and human voices, these new sounds serve no clear message and seem designed to irritate and unnerve. "At least the old broadcasts were human sounds we could bear," said another villager, reflecting on how tensions between the Koreas have evolved.

The sonic assault is part of a broader escalation in tensions between North and South Korea. With North Korean leader Kim Jong-un abandoning dialogue with South Korea and the United States, and South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol increasing military drills with allies, the two countries have become locked in a cycle of provocative actions. North Korea's new sound strategy follows a period of retaliation against South Korean broadcasts, which included sending balloons filled with trash in response to anti-Kim leaflets and resuming propaganda broadcasts of its own.





In September 2023, the funeral home partnered with a funeral supply company to launch the coffin cafe on the first floor of its main building. The cafe features three uniquely designed coffins, each in a different color—gold, green, and yellow—adorned with floral patterns and soothing motifs. The goal is to create a calm and contemplative environment where visitors can lie in the coffins, take time to reflect on their lives, and think about their eventual passing.

Visitors can experience the coffin cafe for a fee of 2,200 yen (around \$14), and many have found it to be a powerful way to reflect on life's impermanence. The experi-



ence has drawn a variety of guests, including couples who take photos inside the coffins and others who choose to close the lid for a moment of personal reflection.

Kiyotaka Hirano, the president of Kajiya Honten, explained that the idea for the coffin cafe came from his own experience of losing his father unexpectedly at a young age. Hirano believes that the experience can offer visitors a "rebirth," a chance to reset and renew their lives by confronting their own mortality.

Kajiya Honten aims to stand out by offering personalized services and unique experiences, ensuring that its century-old legacy remains relevant in today's changing world.

Revolutionary Or Deceptive? China's Robotic Fish Raise Eyebrows

Alife-size robot-ic whale shark at Xiaomeisha Sea World in Shenzhen has sparked controversy, with some visitors feeling deceived after paying the hefty entry fee of 230 yuan (around Rs 2,680). The artificial creature, which was introduced after the aquarium's reopening in October, has left a section of the public upset, as they expected to see a real whale shark in the water, not a mechanical replica.



Videos of the robotic whale shark gliding through the aquarium's tanks have been circulating online, showing the lifelike appearance of the creature. However, many visitors were taken aback to discover that it was not a living animal but a technologically advanced robot. Some expressed their dissatisfaction by posting complaints on Dazhong Dianping, a popular Chinese review platform, questioning the aquarium's authenticity and accusing it of misleading customers.

One disgruntled visitor wrote, "I cannot believe the whale shark is fake. It's outrageous to charge over 200 yuan for a ticket." Another commenter went as far as threatening to report the aquarium to authorities, saying, "I will have this place shut down for tricking people with a fake whale shark."

The incident has divided opinion, with some defending the aquarium's use of technology, arguing that

the robotic whale shark offers a unique experience for visitors. Proponents of the attraction note that the artificial shark is an impressive feat of engineering, capable of mimicking the movements of a real whale shark in a way that some find fascinating.

Despite the mixed reactions, the controversy has drawn attention to the growing trend of using artificial creatures in lieu of real marine life in aquariums. While some visitors may appreciate the innovation, others feel disappointed by the lack of transparency about the nature of the exhibit, especially given the premium ticket prices.

As the debate continues online, Xiaomeisha Sea World may need to reassess its approach to customer expectations, balancing technological innovation with clear communication about what visitors can expect from their experience.

World's Longest Experiment Could Last Another Century

The *Pitch Drop Exper-**⊥** iment*, recognized by the Guinness World Records as the longest-running scientific experiment, is set to continue its slow march through time, potentially for another century. Held at the University of Queensland in Australia, this experiment, which has been ongoing since 1927, is an unusual demonstration of viscosity using a substance called pitch—a tar derivative known for being the world's thickest liquid.



Originally conceived by Australian physicist Thomas Parnell, the experiment aimed to measure the fluidity of pitch, which, despite appearing solid at room temperature, behaves like a thick, slow-moving liquid. Parnell poured a sample of pitch into a glass funnel and allowed it to cool and settle for three years before cutting the funnel's stem. Since then, the pitch has been dripping, but at an extraordinarily slow rate, dropping only nine times in almost a century. The next drop is expected sometime this decade.

The experiment, which was set up as a simple demonstration, has been left in a display cabinet at the university, where it is subject to the changing seasons and varying temperatures. These fluctuations impact the rate at which the pitch flows, making the drops even rarer. Over the years, the

experiment has become a source of fascination for both scientists and the public, particularly since no one has ever been present to witness the fall of a drop due to the unpredictable timing.

Professor John Mainstone took over as the custodian of the experiment in 1961, overseeing it for more than five decades until his death in 2013. Despite the slow pace, the experiment's findings have proven significant. Pitch, though brittle and solid-looking at room temperature, flows with a viscosity 100 billion times greater than that of water. Remarkably, there is still enough pitch in the funnel to keep the experiment running for another 100 years.

In 2005, Parnell (posthumously) and Mainstone received the Ig Nobel Prize, a satirical award that celebrates odd yet thought-provoking scientific research, for their work with the Pitch Drop Experiment.

Plastic waste could double by 2050, researchers find

Anew study has raised alarm over the growing plastic waste crisis, predicting that global plastic waste could double by 2050 unless urgent action is taken. However, the research also highlights that effective policies, including increasing the use of recycled plastics and investing in improved waste management systems, could significantly reduce plastic waste by more than 90% and cut related emissions by a third.

The study, conducted by a team of researchers, warns that without substantial changes, plastic waste could increase from 460 million tonnes today to more than 1 billion tonnes by mid-century. This dramatic rise is driven by the continued use of single-use plastics and insufficient recycling efforts worldwide. The researchers emphasized that plastic pollution is not only a waste issue but also a major environmental concern, contributing to ocean pollution, landfills, and harmful emissions.

To address the issue, the study suggests several key measures. One of the most impactful solutions would be to substantially increase the use of recycled plastics. By using more recycled materials in manufacturing, the demand for virgin plastics would decrease, leading to less waste. Another crucial strategy is improving global waste management infrastructure, particularly in developing countries where many plastics



end up in landfills or oceans due to inadequate disposal systems.

In addition, the study advocates for policies to reduce plastic consumption, such as bans on single-use plastics and incentives for companies to adopt circular economy practices, where products are designed for reuse and recycling. Governments, businesses, and consumers would need to work together to implement these strategies, with the potential to drastically reduce both plastic waste and the carbon footprint associated with plastic production.

By adopting these measures, the study concludes that the world could not only curb plastic waste but also significantly mitigate the environmental damage caused by plastic production and disposal. The researchers stressed that immediate and coordinated action is necessary to prevent the crisis from worsening over the next few decades.
