

Five decades of dream to be fulfilled



TPN, Telangana: In a significant development for Telangana, the central government has taken a major step towards fulfilling the long-standing demand for a coach factory in Kazipet. The establishment of the factory, set to cost around Rs. 500 crore, will provide direct and indirect employment to ap-

proximately 2,000 people, a boost for the local economy.

Kazipet has been a focal point for railway activities, particularly since the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh. The demand for a coach factory in Kazipet dates back to the 1969 Telangana movement, with

residents agitating for a manufacturing unit in the region. In 2014, the central government included the coach factory as part of the bifurcation promises. The Telangana government allocated 150 acres of land, but the project faced several setbacks. Despite the promise in the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act of 2014, the project was delayed. In 2017, the central government announced that no new coach factories would be established, and instead, a coach factory was set up in Latur, Maharashtra, with a Rs. 625 crore budget.

Pressure from Telangana led to the announcement in 2023 of a railway wagon manufacturing industry in Kazipet, but this decision did not provide the same benefits as a coach factory. Locals argue that the wagon industry will only offer employment to around 2,000 people, while a coach factory could generate

em ployment for up to 60,000 individuals.

# CM Revanth Orders Action on School Food Negligence

TPN, Telangana: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has issued a stern directive to district Collectors, instructing them to treat students in government schools, hostels, and Gurukul educational institutions as their own children and ensure they receive nutritious food in a clean environment.

Expressing strong dissatisfaction over recurring incidents involving poor food quality in schools, CM Revanth emphasized that action will be taken against officials and staff found neglecting their duties in this regard. He warned that those proven negligent will face removal from their positions. The Chief Minister further directed the Collectors to conduct regular inspections of schools, hostels, and Gurukuls, and submit detailed reports.

Reaffirming the government's commitment to improving the education system, which he claimed had deteriorated over the past decade, CM Revanth stated that his administration is working dili-



gently to restore the system to its rightful course.

Additionally, CM Revanth condemned those spreading false information to malign the government's efforts, particularly concerning student welfare. He instructed officials to take strict action against individuals spreading rumors and creating unnecessary panic among parents. The Chief Minister's directive underscores his resolve to improve the quality of education and ensure the safety and well-being of students across the state.

Speaking to the media at Telangana Bhavan in Hyderabad on Thursday, Rao accused the government of misleading both Parliament and the public regarding the Musi project. He was particularly vocal about the demolition of houses under the Musi proj-

ect and the lack of proper compensation for affected residents.


Rao claimed that the current government, under CM Revanth Reddy, has been deceitful by providing false information to the Center, stating that no new houses would be demolished, while in reality, many houses had already been torn down. He questioned how compensation would be paid for these demolished houses and criticized the government's failure to follow necessary protocols, such as conducting surveys, issuing notices, or considering objections before demolitions took place. He stated that while the BRS party supports the revival of the Musi River, they oppose the real estate ventures being disguised as part of the project.


#### Govt to Amend MPP Structure for Elections

TPN , Telangana : The state government is preparing for the upcoming Panchayat elections, expected to take place in the second week of February. A notification is likely to be issued on January 14, and elections will be conducted in three phases. In addition to election preparations, the government plans to introduce key amendments in the Panchayat Raj department. One significant change includes the formation of a Mandal Parishad President (MPP) with a minimum of five Mandal Parishad Territorial Constituencies (MPTCs).

Kazipet Junction, a key gateway to South India, is crucial for coal transportation and connects Northern and Southern India. More than 200 passenger and freight trains pass through Kazipet daily, making it one of the highest revenue-generating junctions in India. There has been increasing support for making Kazipet a full-fledged railway division, considering its importance in the region's rail network.

Despite the setbacks, the central government's decision to establish a railway manufacturing unit in Kazipet marks a long-awaited step in fulfilling a key promise made to the people of Telangana. However, local leaders and citizens continue to question whether this will provide the full benefits that a dedicated coach factory would have brought. The debate over the feasibility and the true impact of the project remains ongoing.

Rao accused the state government of using the Musi project as an excuse to divert state funds for personal profit, without benefiting the people who were displaced.

Rao further defended the 2014 Land Acquisition Act, which was introduced by KCR, stating that it provided displaced families with significant compensation and benefits, including larger plots of land and better housing. However, he condemned the current government's actions, claiming that it had failed to uphold the provisions of the Act and had handed out houses to Musi victims with no real ownership rights. He pointed out that the houses were provided with only assigned papers, and the residents had no claim over the properties.

Harish Rao emphasized that BRS would continue to fight for the rights of Musi victims, demanding that the state government provide adequate compensation as promised under the 2014 Act. He also promised to hold the government accountable for the pain and suffering caused to the displaced families.

#### Big Changes in 10<sup>th</sup> Class Exams: 100-Mark **Paper Introduced**

TPN, Telangana: The Telangana Education Department has announced significant changes to the 10th class exam pattern, just three months ahead of the exams. In a key decision, the department revealed that the 10th class exams will now have a single paper worth 100 marks. Previously, the exam was for 80 marks, with the remaining 20 marks allocated for internal exams.

The new decision removes the internal exam system entirely, meaning that the entire 100 marks will now come from the main exam. Students will need to adjust their preparation accordingly as they focus on the full 100-mark paper. The education department's announcement is expected to have a significant impact on exam preparations for the upcoming academic year.

# Talasani Refutes Allegations Over Nirmal Ethanol Factory



TPN , Hyderabad: BRS leader and former minister Talasani Srinivas strongly denied allegations regarding his family's involvement with the upcoming ethanol factory in Dilawarpur mandal, Nirmal district. Speaking to the media on Thursday, November 28, Talasani clarified that while his son, Talasani Sai Kiran, served as the director of the ethanol factory for three

months in 2016, no permissions were granted during his tenure.

"This is an attempt to defame me and my party. If anyone can prove that my son owns the factory, I will transfer ownership immediately," Talasani asserted.

The allegations stemmed from comments made by Bhuvanagiri Congress MP Ch Kiran Kumar Reddy, who claimed that the BRS government had granted permissions for the factory in 2022. He also accused Talasani's son of being the director of PMK Distillations Pvt Ltd, the compa-

ny behind the ethanol project.

The factory has sparked protests from farmers in Nirmal district, who argue it would not benefit them. On Wednesday, farmers staged a sit-in on the national highway, and the government has since paused construction, with officials reconsidering the factory's approval.

#### Minister Komatireddy Venkat Reddy Criticizes KTR and Harish Rao



TPN , Hyderabad: Minister Komatireddy Venkat Reddy sharply criticized BRS leaders KTR and Harish Rao for their lack of response to his previous comments. Speaking to the media, he questioned their entry into politics, remarking that they rose to power because of their connections as the son and daughter-in-law of Chief Minister

#### Kadiyam Srihari Launches Scathing Attack on BRS Leadership

TPN, Jangaon: Senior Congress leader and MLA Kadiyam Srihari criticized the BRS leadership, accusing them of corruption, mismanagement, and failure to deliver on promises.

The committee will visit these schools every 15 days to monitor conditions and prepare reports. He also emphasized the importance of regular health checkups for students.

In line with Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's vision, the Minister outlined measures to improve the quality of Gurukuls and ensure proper nutrition and cleanliness. He urged principals to report any issues to the District Collector and assured that the government would take all necessary steps to address them.

# Rapid Depletion of Srisailam **Project's Water Raises Concerns**

TPN , Telangana : The Srisailam project, which recently reached full capacity due to heavy rains, is now facing a sudden and sharp decline in water levels. Official reports indicate that the reservoir's storage has dropped from 215 TMC (thousand million cubic feet) to 130 TMC as of Thursday, primarily due to excessive power generation activities by the right and left bank power plants operated by Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

The reservoir's current water level has fallen to 867.40 feet from its full level of 885 feet. While power generation has ceased on the right bank, it continues on the left bank, contributing to an outflow of 35,315 cusecs daily.

reservoir could be emptied within the next two months, potentially leading to severe water shortages in the summer. The dual pressures of power generation and declining water levels underscore the need for balanced resource



Experts caution that if this rate of depletion persists, the management to ensure both energy production and water availability are sustained in the region.

#### **Global Oil Market Outlook: OPEC, Geopolitics, and U.S. Shale Production**



The global oil market is currently in a phase of moderation, with prices hovering in the range of \$70-74 per barrel — the lowest levels seen since the onset of the Russia-Ukraine war in February 2022. For major importers like India, this trend provides some relief, easing the financial burden of high energy costs. However, the outlook for next year remains uncertain, with a variety of factors influencing oil price trends. The decisions made during the upcoming December 1 meeting of the Organisation of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) will play a key role in shaping the market's direction in the short term.

OPEC, which includes some of the world's largest oil-producing countries, is expected to maintain its current output curbs during the meeting, extending the restrictions that were initially set to be eased gradually from next month. This decision will likely push the timeline for easing production cuts into the new year, as the group aims to balance supply and demand while managing price fluctuations. Much of the future oil price trajectory will depend on geopolitical factors, particularly the ongoing tensions between Russia and Ukraine, as well as the broader state of China's economy. Geopolitical developments are already having an impact, with oil prices rising briefly in recent days due to escalating tensions in the Russia-Ukraine conflict. However, the price surge was short-lived, and oil prices have since fallen back to around \$73 per barrel for Brent crude and \$69.18 for West Texas Intermediate. These fluctuations highlight the ongoing volatility in the market, where any shift in global events could dramatically alter price expectations.

Adding to the complexity of the situation is the political climate in the United States. The upcoming presidency of Donald Trump, if he secures the position, could also influence the global oil landscape. Trump's "drill baby drill" rhetoric, aimed at boosting domestic oil production, has raised speculation that U.S. shale oil companies may ramp up output. While this could lower gasoline prices for U.S. consumers — a key campaign promise — it could also push global oil prices down further, a scenario that oil producers may be reluctant to embrace. The fossil fuel companies backing Trump are focused on maintaining profits rather than increasing output at the risk of oversupply, which could soften global prices.

# The Dangers of Citizen Journalism: Idealism vs. Reality



Citizen journalism has gained significant traction in recent years, driven the role citizen journalists have played largely by advancements in technology and social media platforms. Elon Musk, after acquiring 'X' (formerly Twitter), has strongly advocated for citizen journalism, positioning the platform as a "digital town square" and a direct alternative to traditional media. He envisions a world where ordinary people, rather than professional journalists, shape the news cycle by sharing real-time, on-the-ground information.

However, while citizen journalism holds the promise of democratizing information and challenging the biases of traditional media, it has its own set of challenges. As Musk himself has claimed, citizen journalism allows for the aggregation of insights from people directly involved in events, bypassing the filters of traditional newsrooms.

This could be seen as an extension of historically, from freedom fighters nalism requires specialized skills during India's struggle for independence to ordinary citizens capturing critical moments like the assassination of President John F. Kennedy or the Mumbai terror attacks.

Yet, the rise of citizen journalism comes at a cost. The absence of editorial oversight means that platforms like 'X' have become breeding grounds for misinformation, hate speech, and extremist views. Recent events, including the rise of racist and misogynistic content, highlight the dark side of a decentralized, unregulated news ecosystem. Musk's vision, while well-intentioned, has inadvertently allowed these harmful elements to proliferate, turning social media platforms into echo chambers of bias and vitriol. Moreover, the idea that citizen jour-

nalism can fully replace professional journalists is deeply problematic. Jourinvestigative techniques, an understanding of systems, and the ability to challenge those in power. While anyone with a smartphone can report on an event, they lack the expertise and accountability that trained journalists provide. As Shekhar Gupta, a senior journalist, once pointed out, "Give me citizen doctors and citizen lawyers, and I'll give you citizen journalists."

In conclusion, while citizen journalism offers valuable opportunities for people to share their stories, it cannot replace the professionalism and integrity of traditional journalism. The challenge for both citizen journalists and professional media is to strike a balance that ensures information is accurate, responsible, and accessible

### The Rise and Fall of India's **Aviation Industry: A Historical Perspective**

As India neared independence in 1947, the country's aviation industry was poised for success, benefiting from two key factors. Firstly, there were two sound private airlines, Tata Airlines and Indian National Airways, which were financially stable and experienced in operating modern aircraft. Both airlines had also been supported by the government during World War II, when their planes were requisitioned for wartime services. Secondly, the country reaped long-term benefits from the war, which brought significant advancements in aviation infrastructure, including the construction of 48 aerodromes and expanded meteorological services.

Despite these favorable conditions, the Indian aviation industry faltered

due to a series of poor decisions made by the government. The creation of the Air Licensing Transport Board in 1946, under Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru's administration, was one such blunder. The Board's decision to grant numerous licenses and approve over 100 route applications led to excessive competition, skyrocketing costs, and wasted resources. The situation worsened when, in 1950, the government ignored recommendations from a com-



mittee led by Justice GS Rajadhyaksha, which advised against nationalization and called for consolidation of airlines to ensure economic viability. Instead, the government pursued a nationalization agenda that ultimately crippled the industry. In 1953, the passage of the Air Corporations Act formalized the nationalization of Indian aviation. The government created Air India and Indian Airlines as state-run monopolies, stifling private enterprise. The rationale behind nationalization included the desire to better utilize resources, enhance defense capabilities, and plan the future of aviation on a national scale. However, the government's approach proved to be a disaster, stunting growth and innovation in the sector for decades.

It wasn't until 1994, with the repeal of the Air Corporations Act, that India's aviation market began to show signs of recovery. The sector was liberalized, allowing private carriers to re-enter the market. However, the rapid rise and fall of airlines, coupled with structural issues, has led to a high failure rate. By 2024, over 40 airlines have ceased operations or merged, highlighting the challenges of building a sustainable aviation industry.

Looking ahead, India is now the world's third-largest aviation market, and its domestic air travel is projected to grow exponentially by 2030. Yet, the country faces critical infrastructure challenges, including the need for more airports, upgraded facilities, and an efficient regulatory environment. To truly realize its aviation potential, India requires a comprehensive, long-term strategy for developing a sustainable and competitive aviation sector.

As the Maha Yuti coalition continues its crucial discussions to determine the new Chief Minister of Maharashtra, the Shiv Sena on Thursday expressed its admiration for Eknath Shinde, praising his "humility and sense of duty." While the party has hinted that Shinde may not serve as the deputy chief minister in the new government, it has left open the possibility of his inclusion in the upcoming Council of Ministers.

Eknath Shinde, 60, rose to prominence after leading a rebellion that toppled the Uddhav Thackeray-led Maha Vikas Aghadi gov-

ernment, which consisted of the Shiv Sena, Nationalist Congress Party (NCP), and Congress. After the collapse of that alliance, Shinde became the leader of the Shiv Sena faction that aligned with the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and eventually assumed the position of Chief Minister on June 30, 2022. His tenure as Maharashtra's CM lasted until November 27, 2024.

During Shinde's tenure, the state saw significant political changes, with BJP's Devendra Fadnavis and NCP's Ajit Pawar both serving as deputy chief ministers in a government that

was formed under the Shiv Sena's leadership. Shinde's political maneuvering and ability to consolidate power played a key role in his ascent to the top position in the state.

The ongoing discussions in the Maha Yuti alliance are set to decide the future political direction of Maharashtra, with key roles being discussed for various party leaders. While Shiv Sena has not indicated whether Shinde will retain the Chief Minister's post, the praise for his leadership highlights his crucial role in the party and state politics.

The event was marked by the presence of key leaders from the opposition I.N.D.I.A. alliance, including Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge, Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi, and West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, among others.

Before the oath-taking ceremony, Soren, dressed in a kurta and pyjama, met with JMM President and his father, Shibu Soren, for a brief discussion. This marks Hemant Soren's fourth term as Chief Minister, following his victory in the recent assembly elections. Soren secured a commanding win in his Barhait constituency, defeating BJP's Gamliyel Hembrom by a margin of 39,791

# Malaysia PM Reports Floods Displace **Thousands Across Six States**

More than 37,000 people have been displaced by severe flooding caused by heavy rainfall across six states in Malaysia, Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim announced on Thursday. The floods, which have caused widespread damage, have left thousands in need of shelter and assistance.

Anwar revealed in a parliamentary statement that 322 temporary shelters had been set up in the states of Kelantan, Terengganu, Kedah, Perlis, Johor, and Perak to accommodate those affected by the floods. The worst-hit area is Kelantan, located on Malaysia's north-eastern border with Thailand. In Kelantan alone, 30,582 individuals from 9,223 families have been impacted by the relentless rains and rising waters.

The monsoon season in Malaysia, which lasts from October to March, is known for bringing intense rainfall and floods, particularly to the eastern coastal regions. Each year, these floods



displace thousands of people and cause significant disruption. This year, the severe weather conditions have once again put immense pressure on local communities and emergency services.

To manage the crisis, Malaysia's National Disaster Management Agency has been directed to coordinate with both federal and state agencies to ensure the safety of flood victims and residents throughout the duration of the monsoon season. Authorities have mobilized resources to provide immediate relief, including food, medical supplies, and temporary shelter, to those affected by the floodwaters.

While Malaysia frequently experiences flooding during the monsoon period, the scale and intensity of this year's floods have raised concerns about the ongoing challenges of disaster preparedness and response. As the floodwaters continue to impact communities, authorities are working to mitigate further damage and ensure that those affected receive the necessary support.

## hold military level talks on counterterrorism

Pakistan and China's military officials held crucial talks this week, focusing on counter-terrorism efforts and regional security concerns. General Zhang Youxia, the Vice Chairman of China's Central Military Commission (CMC), led a high-level delegation to Pakistan for discussions with Pakistan's Army Chief, General Asim Munir.

A central focus of the talks was Pakistan's ongoing counter-terrorism efforts, which have become increasingly important due to rising attacks on Chinese nationals working in Pakistan. The safety of Chinese citizens has become a significant issue, with China reportedly seeking a more proactive role in ensuring their protection. Despite this, Pakistan's Foreign Office has stressed that counter-terrorism cooperation between the two nations remains robust.

In addition to counter-terrorism discussions, the military delegations also addressed regional stability concerns. Notably, they exchanged views on the role of India in the region and the security situation in Afghanistan. The presence of terrorist groups in Afghanistan was highlighted as a critical issue that continues to affect regional peace.



#### **'Hindu Monk's Arrest Unjust, Must Be** Freed': Bangladesh **Ex-PM Sheikh Hasina**

Sheikh Hasina, the ousted prime minister of Bangladesh, has strongly condemned the arrest of a Hindu priest and the escalating violence that followed in the country. In a statement today, Hasina expressed outrage over the arrest of a prominent leader of the Sanatan religious community, calling for his immediate release. She also decried the burning of a temple in Chittagong and highlighted previous attacks on various religious communities, including mosques, churches, monasteries, and the homes of the Ahmadiyya community. "Religious freedom and the security of life and property for all communities must be ensured," Hasina said, underscoring the need for equal protection under the law for all citizens, regardless of faith.

The former prime minister also expressed serious concerns about the interim government's handling of the country's economy and law and order. She criticized the current authorities for failing to control the rising prices of daily necessities and for their inability to protect citizens from violence. "The current power grabbers have failed in every area.

#### **Biden Administration Plans \$725 Million Weapons Package for Ukraine**



The Biden administration is preparing a significant \$725 million weapons package to support Ukraine in its ongoing war with Russia, officials confirmed on Wednesday. The new package, which is expected to be announced soon, comes as President Biden seeks to reinforce Kyiv's defenses before leaving office in January.

The package will include a range of anti-tank weapons from U.S. stocks, aimed at countering Russia's advancing forces. Among the supplies are land mines, drones, Stinger missiles, and ammunition for High Mobility Artillery Rocket Systems (HIMARS). Additionally, cluster munitions, typically used in Guided Multiple Launch Rocket System (GMLRS) rockets, are expected to be part of the package.

The formal notification of the weapons package could be delivered to Congress as early as Monday, although the exact size and contents may still change before President Biden signs it into law. This marks a notable increase in the scale of U.S. assistance, with previous presidential drawdown packages usually ranging from \$125 million to \$250 million. Biden has authorized approximately \$4 to \$5 billion in Presidential Drawdown Authority (PDA), which allows the U.S. to provide weapons from its current stock-

The inclusion of landmines is controversial, as the United States has not exported them for decades due to concerns over civilian harm. Despite this, Kyiv has requested landmines since Russia's invasion began in 2022, and Russia itself has used them on the front lines. The mines being sent are non-persistent, meaning they are designed to be temporary and will not remain a threat to civilians after they are activated.

As Russia's forces continue to make significant territorial gains in Ukraine, the U.S. is ramping up military support to help bolster Ukraine's defenses. Meanwhile, President-elect Donald Trump has appointed retired General Keith Kellogg as his special envoy for the Ukraine conflict, with plans to find a swift resolution to the war, a key campaign promise.

#### **Ukraine Faces Escalating Energy Crisis Amid Ongoing Missile Attacks**

Ukraine's energy infrastructure is under severe assault, with the country experiencing massive missile attacks targeting critical energy facilities. The attacks have prompted nationwide air raid alerts and urgent emergency power cuts, as temperatures plummet to freezing levels. Energy Minister German Galushchenko confirmed on Thursday that the country is facing extensive disruptions, with power outages affecting regions like Kyiv, Odesa, Dnipro, and Donetsk. The situation is dire, as Russia continues to target Ukraine's energy infrastructure, exacerbating the already difficult conditions of the war.



The missile strike comes just a day after U.S. president-elect Donald Trump appointed retired General Keith Kellogg as his special en-

voy for Ukraine, a move that has raised concerns regarding future U.S. military support for Ukraine. Trump, who campaigned on ending the war, has suggested that U.S. military aid could be used as leverage to push Ukraine into peace talks with Russia. The court emphasized the importance of maintaining law and order and ensuring the safety of citizens and their property in Bangladesh.

The Dhaka High Court on Thursday declined to issue a suo motu order to ban the International Society for Krishna Consciousness (ISKCON) in Bangladesh. The decision came after the court was informed that the government had already taken necessary actions concerning the matter, The Daily Star reported.

The petition, submitted by Supreme Court lawyer Md Monir Uddin, was based on newspaper reports about ISKCON's activities in Bangladesh. Uddin requested the court to impose a ban on the organization and enforce Section 144 in the regions of Chattogram, Rangpur, and Dinajpur to curb its activities. The petition also sought to address growing concerns over violence and communal tensions in the country.

In response, the court instructed the attor-

cused ISKCON of being a "radical organization" that posed a threat to national security and fueled communal unrest. The petitioners, who included 10 legal professionals, also called for the prosecution of those responsible for the alleged murder of government legal officer Advocate Saiful Islam, which had sparked widespread protests and tensions.

#### India's Economic **Outlook: Cautiously Optimistic with Positive Agricultural Prospects**



**T**ndia's economic outlook for the upcoming months is **■** described as "cautiously optimistic," with agriculture poised to benefit from favourable monsoon conditions, higher minimum support prices (MSPs), and a steady supply of inputs, according to a report by the Finance Ministry.

The October edition of the \*Monthly Economic Review\*, released by the Department of Economic Affairs, highlights positive agricultural production prospects, which are expected to help keep inflation in check. Despite price pressures in select food items, the report indicates that food inflation will likely ease due to a bumper kharif harvest. While global economic challenges remain a concern, the report suggests that India's economic resilience, particularly in the agriculture sector, is expected to provide a cushion against external uncertainties. The government's focus on increasing MSPs and ensuring input availability is seen as a key strategy for bolstering agricultural productivity, which remains a vital sector for India's economy.

## **Adani Group Shares Surge**; **Adani Total Gas** Soars Nearly 19%

Chares of nine out of the 11 listed Adani Group compa-**J**nies were trading higher during the morning session on Thursday, continuing a strong upward trend seen in recent days. Leading the gains was Adani Total Gas, which surged by 18.58%, followed by Adani Power, which jumped 11.44%. Adani Energy Solutions and Adani Green Energy also saw impressive gains, both rising by 9.99% on the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE).

Other Adani Group stocks that registered gains included Adani Enterprises, which climbed 5.32%, NDTV with a 3.35% rise, Adani Wilmar up 3.17%, Adani Ports increasing by 2.25%, and Sanghi Industries rising by 2.19%.

The upward momentum was not limited to Thursday, as all Adani Group stocks had ended sharply higher in the previous trading session on Wednesday. 

The book, purchased for just 10 pounds over 30 years ago, was sold for £45,000 (around Rs 48 lakh) after a successful bidding war. The auction took place in Lichfield, Staffordshire, where Hansons Auctioneers hosted the sale, confirming the book's incredible value.

The copy of the book, bought by Christine McCulloch for her son Adam in 1997 from a bookstore in Stratford-upon-Avon, had remained hidden in a cupboard under the stairs in their Chesterfield home for years. It was only after the family learned about the significant value J.K. Rowling's magical world. of first-edition \*Harry Potter\* books during the 2020 lockdown that they realized the treasure they had. Adam McCulloch described the discovery as a "pinch yourself moment" when the book was verified.

This particular first edition is one of the 500 hardback copies printed during the initial 1997 run of \*Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone\*. Experts estimate the value of such rare editions ranges between 30,000 pounds (Rs 32 lakh) and 50,000 pounds (Rs 53 lakh), making this auction price within the expected range. The book's rarity and the ongoing global fascination with the \*Harry Potter\* series have contributed to its high auction value.

Christine McCulloch fondly recalled buying the book for her son, unaware of the future value it would hold. Adam's deep connection to the book, which started his lifelong fascination with the series, mirrors the experiences of countless readers worldwide who were captivated by

The audio recording feature allows both drivers and passengers to record conversations if they feel unsafe during a ride. These recordings are encrypted, stored securely, and can only be accessed by Uber if submitted as part of a safe-

ty report. This feature complies with India's one-party consent law and is its driver base. now available across the country.

Additionally, Uber has launched a women rider preference option, which allows women drivers to select only female passengers. This feature, which was introduced based on feedback from women drivers, has been particularly useful for rides during late hours, providing a safer environment. So far, over 21,000 trips have been completed using this feature. Uber is also focused on increasing the number of female drivers in India, as women currently represent just 2% of scription terms.

In a separate development, Uber is currently under investigation by the US Federal Trade Commission (FTC) over potential violations of consumer protection laws related to its Uber One subscription service. The FTC is scrutinizing the enrollment and cancellation processes of the program, which offers subscribers discounts on rides and delivery services for an annual fee. The investigation, which began earlier this year, stems from concerns over the ease of cancellation and sub-




