BJP MP Raghunandan Rao also dismissed the remarks, calling them a publicity stunt.

A Counter to BRS's Social Media Campaign?

Some analysts believe Ponguleti's statements were an effort to counter BRS's recent negative allegations surrounding the minister's trip to Seoul. BRS social media channels suggested that Ponguleti and other ministers' overseas visit was a misuse of public funds, alleging they traveled for personal gain under the guise of a beautification project for Hyderabad's Musi River. Rumors circulated that Congress may have urged Ponguleti to make bold remarks as a strategic response to this criticism.

Are Ponauleti's "Bombs" a Hoax or Real Threat?

With no arrests occurring, many are left questioning whether Ponguleti's "political bombs" were merely a bluff. Despite a media frenzy suggesting imminent action against prominent figures such as KTR, none of these speculated events materialized. Adding to the suspense, rumors surfaced that KTR's brother-in-law had held a party where drugs were allegedly discovered, further fueling spec-

Whether Ponguleti's remarks were based on fact or strategy, they have undoubtedly stirred public interest. If arrests do follow, they could signal a major upheaval in Telangana politics. If not, his remarks will be remembered as a moment of heightened intrigue that, in the end, was only a political tactic.

"Emergency days seem to have returned to Telangana," KTR stated. "In our democratic state, people are once again hearing the sound of authoritarian footsteps. Revanth Reddy Counters PM Modi, Highlights Major Reforms in Telangana

TPN , Hyderabad : Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy issued a strong rebuttal to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's recent comments on Telangana's governance, addressing them on the social media platform X. CM Revanth accused the Center of spreading misconceptions about his administration, asserting that Telangana has witnessed a new era of progress since the Congress took office on December 7, 2023, following nearly a decade of BRS rule.

In his response, Revanth highlighted the swift implementation of key promises by his government within days of assuming office. He noted that free bus

Additionally, he highlighted free electricity up to 200 units for households, which he claimed has brought significant relief to families across Telangana.

Telangana Government Announces Selection Process for Indiramma Houses



TPN, Hyderabad: The Telangana government has officially unveiled the selection process for beneficiaries of the Indiramma Houses, confirming that the allotment will occur in four phases. Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Red-

dy announced the launch of a dedicated apperry homeless individual in Telangana, with to facilitate the selection process, ensuring that it is efficient and transparent.

The construction of each house will cover an area of 400 square feet, with the government providing Rs 5 lakh to beneficiaries who own land. Minister Ponguleti emphasized that the selection criteria will be unbiased, allowing eligible individuals access to Indiramma houses regardless of their political affiliations or regions. The scheme is expected to roll out soon, with final preparations underway.

To accommodate rural populations, the app will feature a Telugu version. Minister Ponguleti directed officials to leverage technology at every stage, from beneficiary selection to house completion. The government aims to provide an Indiramma house to ev-

plans to build between 3,500 and 4,000 houses in the first phase alone. Over the next four years, the target is to construct a total of 20 lakh houses.

Despite these advancements, tensions have emerged regarding the formation of Indiramma Committees, as BRS representatives in several villages are clashing with Congress leaders who demand their exclusion from the committees. This situation has created challenges for local authorities.

Responding to speculation about Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's potential replacement, Minister Ponguleti asserted that Revanth would remain in office for the entire term, dismissing opposition claims as unfounded and politically motivated.

Harish Rao Criticizes Revanth Reddy's Claims in Letter to Modi

TPN, Hyderabad: Former minister and BRS leader Harish Rao has launched a scathing counterattack against Chief Minister Revanth Reddy following Reddy's letter to Prime Minister Narendra Modi highlighting the schemes and development initiatives in Telangana. Rao criticized the Congress government for failing to deliver on numerous promises made to the electorate. In a detailed post on Twitter, Harish Rao pointed out that during the BRS's nine-year administration, 161,000 jobs were filled, contrasting this with the 50,000 jobs that Reddy claims were appointed after assuming office, which he argues were initiated while the BRS was still in power. He emphasized that the job appointment process was hindered by the Election Code, not by the BRS.

Rao accused Reddy of misleading the public about job fulfillment and questioned the Congress party's commitment to its electoral promises, including the pledge to provide 200,000 jobs in the first year.



He also expressed concern over the Congress government's handling of loan waivers for farmers, claiming many are still waiting for the promised relief. Moreover, Rao highlighted Congress's failure to implement its commitments regarding pensions and financial support for women and students. He pointed out that several welfare schemes initiated under the previous BRS government remain unfulfilled. He tagged Congress leaders Rahul Gandhi and AICC president Mallikarjuna Kharge in his post, accusing them of deceiving the people of Telangana.

Telangana Schools Adjust **Hours for Caste Census**

TPN , Telangana : The Telangana government has announced new operating hours for primary schools in light of the upcoming caste census, which will begin on November 6. Under the new schedule, primary schools will operate from 9 AM to 1 PM, while high schools will maintain their usual hours.

This change is necessary to allow primary school teachers to participate in the census, which is expected to last for three weeks. The government has assured that midday meals will continue to be provided to students, even with the adjusted hours. Approximately 36,559 secondary grade teachers and 3,414 primary school principals will assist in the caste enumeration. An additional 50,000 employees from the School Education Department, including non-teaching staff, will also participate in the door-to-door survey.

The Planning Department has ordered Secondary Grade Teachers (SGTs) and Primary School Head Masters (PSHMs) to engage in enumerator duties throughout the day, including on holidays. However, teachers in upper primary and high schools will not be required to participate in the enumeration process, allowing them to continue their regular school

Telangana's Voter Registration **Surpasses 3.34 Crore**

Final List to Be Announced in January

darshan Reddy announced that Telangana's final voter count has reached 3,34,26,323, including 8 lakh newly registered voters. This update follows the release of the draft voter list on September 29.Reddy revealed that 4.14 lakh voters were removed from the list, while 4,73,838 youth voters were successfully registered. The number of polling stations across the state has increased to 35,907, with the addition of 551 new stations.

Objections to the voter list will be accepted until October 27, with the final list scheduled for publication on January 6, 2025. In an effort to boost voter registration, a special campaign will be held on October 9 and 10, where Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will be available at polling stations throughout the day.

TPN, Hyderabad: Chief Electoral Officer Su-Reddy also clarified that Additional Staff for Temporary duties (ASTs) do not have the right to vote in the Upadhyaya MLC elections. This initiative reflects the Telangana Election Commission's commitment to ensuring a fair and accessible electoral process for all citizens.



Bandi Sanjay Criticizes Congress Guarantees, Claims Unfulfilled Promises

TPN, Hyderabad: Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay has asserted that even 10,000 days would not suffice for the Congress party to implement its guarantees, criticizing Chief Minister Revanth Reddy for what he termed as a platform of empty promises. Sanjay accused the Congress government of deceiving the people of Telangana with false assurances and alleged that it is demolishing the houses of the poor while purportedly building homes under the Prime Minister's Awas Yojana.

During his address, Sanjay expressed concern over the deteriorating law and order situation in the state, highlighting a rise in attacks on temples and a troubling increase in crimes against women, in-



cluding rapes and murders. He further claimed that farmers were misled regarding the promised loan waivers.

Sanjay criticized the Congress for its financial commitments, stating that their unfulfilled promises are driving the state and its citizens deeper into debt. He likened the Congress's plan to give ₹2.5 lakh to every person in Telangana to KCR's previous promise of ₹1 lakh for newborns. He dismissed the Rythu Bharosa scheme and

dairy bonuses as ineffective, stating that many eligible beneficiaries have been left out of schemes such as ₹500 gas cylinders and 200 units of free electricity. Sanjay concluded with a sensational claim that the Musi River would be developed as an additional revenue source, akin to the Kaleswaram project.

BJP MP Dharmapuri Aravind Criticizes Congress and BRS Amid Local Election Preparations

TPN , Telangana : BJP MP Dharmapuri Aravind has launched a scathing attack on both the ruling Congress party and the opposition Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) during his visit to Jagityala on Saturday. In statements to the media, he alleged that a 7% commission is being demanded for the release of bills, underscoring corruption within the government.

Aravind claimed that Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) has severely degraded Telangana in various aspects and accused the newly formed Congress government of failing to deliver any tangible benefits to the populace. Srinivas Goud Pledges Support for BC Reservations Legislation



TPN, Telangana: BRS leader and former minister Srinivas Goud expressed his full support for the Congress government if it enacts a law to secure reservations for backward classes (BCs). During a press conference at Telangana Bhavan on Saturday, he highlighted that without legislative backing, the reservation for BCs cannot be increased. He noted that courts in Bihar and Maharashtra have overturned similar measures due to a lack of proper legislation.

Goud emphasized that BC caste enumeration must adhere to Articles 242 and 343 of the Constitution. He criticized the Congress party for conducting a survey without establishing a legal framework, despite their promise of 42% reservation in local

He raised concerns about the potential divisions among lower classes and stated that the ongoing process should be treated as an MRI, which provides a deeper understanding of caste populations, rather than just an X-ray. Goud also called for accountability from District Collectors regarding the BC Commission's visits and urged the government to convene all-party meetings to discuss the caste system without obstacles. He warned that the state government would be responsible for any future legal complications arising from these issues.

Green Signal for Second Phase of Metro Rail Construction



TPN, **Hyderabad**: The state government has granted administrative approvals for the construction of the second phase of the metro rail project. This phase includes the development of five lines, totaling 76.4 kilometers of metro rail. The government has issued Government Order No. 196 to facilitate these works.

The construction will be carried out in partnership with both the central and state governments, with a total project cost of ₹24,269 crores. The state government is expected to contribute ₹7,313 crores, while funding from international sources like the Zika, ADB, and NDB will amount to ₹11,693 crores. Related works are set to commence soon.

The corridors planned for the second phase are as follows:

- Corridor 4 : Nagol to Shamshabad (36.8 km)
- Corridor 5 : Rayadurgam to Kokapet
- Corridor 6 : MGBS to Chandrayanagutta
- Corridor 7 : Miyapur to Pathan Lake
- Corridor 8 : LB Nagar to Hayat Nagar
- Corridor 9 : Lo Airport to Fourth City (40 km)

This initiative marks a significant step forward in enhancing public transport infrastructure in the region.

Hyderabad Police to Implement Drunk Driving Tests on Outer Ring Road

TPN, **Hyderabad**: In a significant move to combat reckless driving and ensure road safety, the Hyderabad police have announced the introduction of drunk driving tests on the Outer Ring Road (ORR). This initiative comes as part of the Rachakonda police's ongoing efforts to prevent accidents attributed to drunk driving and other dangerous behaviors.

Following a thorough analysis of accident causes on the ORR, the police have identified reckless driving and alcohol consumption as primary factors contributing to numerous incidents. To address these issues, testing for intoxication will soon be conducted at key entry and exit points along the ORR.

In addition, the Rachakonda police have established accident analysis prevention teams to monitor and manage traffic effectively. Commissioner Sudhir Babu has indicated that proposals aimed at enhancing road safety have been submitted to the central government.



To further improve accountability, police officials have acquired 100 body cameras to monitor interactions between traffic police and the public. This comprehensive approach underscores the commitment of the Rachakonda police to creating a safer driving environment for all road users.

Governor Chairs Meeting to Enhance Support for Ex-Servicemen in TG

TPN, **Hyderabad:** On November 2, 2024, Shri Jishnu Dev Varma, the Hon'ble Governor of Telangana, chaired the fourth meeting of the State Managing Committee of the Armed Forces Flag Day Fund at Raj Bhavan. The meeting was attended by key officials from various government departments and representatives from the Ministry of Defence.

Col. P. Ramesh Kumar, Director of Sainik Welfare and Secretary of the Fund, provided an overview of the fund's status, key activities, and beneficiaries. He expressed gratitude to contributors, including government employees and staff from the State Bank of India.

During the meeting, the committee approved several significant measures to enhance support for Ex-Servicemen and their families. Immediate financial assistance was sanctioned for widows of Ex-Servicemen, with Rs. 2 lakh for those with one dependent child under 25 years, and Rs. 3 lakh for widows with two dependent children. The marriage grant for daughters of Ex-Servicemen was increased from Rs. 40,000 to Rs. 50,000, while financial assistance for parents of unmarried soldiers was set at Rs. 3 lakh.

Additionally, the committee raised monthly support for 100% disabled soldiers from Rs. 12,000 to Rs. 15,000, and increased assistance for special children of Ex-Servicemen. Enhanced funeral grants and reimbursements for hostel fees and computer purchases were also approved.

HYDRA Team Visits Bengaluru for Pond Revival Study

TPN, **Hyderabad**: HYDRA Commissioner Ranganath, accompanied by his team, is set to embark on a four-day visit to Bengaluru, Karnataka, to assess the revival of ponds in the city. This trip follows a recent meeting between Ranganath and Anandmalli Gawad, an expert in Indian lake management, where they discussed successful strategies for restoring ponds filled with sewage and lacking water.

In Bengaluru, the team plans to engage with non-profit organizations focused on pond restoration and sewage management. HYDRA officials aim to study the methods employed in Bengaluru's restored ponds and gather insights on how to adapt these policies for implementation in Hyderabad.

Farmers Demand Change in Alignment for Regional Ring Road in Tripular



TPN, Telangana: A peculiar situation has emerged in the northern part of Tripular, where farmers are insisting on altering the alignment for the construction of the Regional Ring Road (RRR). Many have boycotted inquiry meetings organized by revenue officials, expressing frustration over the land acquisition process. The RRR, which spans 352 kilometers and connects 181 villages across seven districts around Hyderabad, has sparked protests in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district. Farmers are concerned about the significant loss of agricultural land and residential areas due to the current alignment, which violates the original guideline requiring a 40-kilometer distance from the Outer Ring Road (ORR). Residents claim the altered alignment has reduced this distance to just 28 kilometers in some areas, resulting in the loss of valuable land.

Although over 70% of the required land-1,927 acres—has been acquired, farmers argue that the compensation offered (be-

tween ₹30 lakh and ₹40 lakh per acre) is far below the market value, which can reach up to ₹4 crore per acre. Complaints have been filed with central ministers, and 32 farmers have approached the courts regarding the construction of an interchange junction at Rayagiri, claiming that the realignment has unjustly affected their livelihoods.

Tragic Accident Claims Lives of Four Family Members in Medak District

The Swachh Bharat Mission: A Decade of Challenges and Unmet Goals

Last month marked the tenth anniversary of cant initiative aimed at improving sanitation across India. Alongside the urban version of the mission, the country has made strides in promoting cleanliness and hygiene. However, each monsoon season reveals the persistent inadequacies in sanitation, sewage, and drainage systems in Indian cities and towns. Poorly constructed toilets, septic tanks, and drainage challenges.

the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), a signifi- In India, the challenge is further complicated by the fact that centralized and capital-intensive sanitation systems are primarily confined to mega-cities, leaving smaller towns and cities disconnected from adequate waste management infrastructure. As a result, managing sanitation and waste effectively in urban areas has emerged as one of India's most pressing



systems frequently choke or overflow, creating hazardous conditions that particularly impact vulnerable populations, including low-income residents, migrants, and sanitation workers.

The stark reality is that only 28 percent of India's urban sewage is treated; the rest is released untreated into rivers, seas, and streams. This environmental neglect exacerbates public health risks, leading to disease outbreaks, especially during the rainy season when urban wastewater hazards become more pronounced. Access to proper sanitation is not merely a matter of convenience; it is a fundamental human right, essential for health, dignity, and productivity. Alarmingly, sanitation remains one of the most off-track Sustainable Development Goals globally, with 43 percent of the world's population lacking access to safe sanitation facilities.

The 2024-2025 budget reflects a lack of urgency regardsanitation improvements. The allocation for drinking water and sanitation stands Rs 77,390.68 crore, representing a meager increase of just 0.5 percent from the previous year. Notably, 90 percent of this budget is directed towards the National Rural Drinking Water Programme, with flagship initiatives like SBM Urban and SBM

Grameen receiving no additional funding. Furthermore, funding for the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and the Smart Cities Mission has been slashed from Rs 13,200 crore to Rs 10,400 crore.

While India has made progress in reducing open defecation—once the highest in the world with about 600 million people defecating outdoors reports indicate that significant issues persist, especially in rural areas. Even towns and cities that have achieved "Open Defecation Free (ODF) Plus" status still struggle with inadequate infrastructure for sewage and wastewater treatment, leaving many residents vulnerable to unsafe excreta disposal. The journey towards a truly clean and sanitary India remains fraught with challenges that require urgent attention

Reevaluating Trade Ties: Pakistan's Shift Towards India

During his recent visit to Washington for the annual meetings of the International Monetary Fund and World Bank, Pakistan's Finance Minister Muhammad Aurangzeb highlighted the importance of trade with neighboring countries, stating that not trading with one's neighbors is "illogical." This comment comes on the heels of Pakistan's decision to sever trade relations with India in 2019, following the abrogation of Article 370, which revoked the special status of Jammu and Kashmir. However, both Pakistan's Prime Minister and Foreign Minister have recently indicated a willingness to explore the possibility of resuming trade ties with India.

The media is now weighing in on the potential benefits of revitalizing trade between the two nations. The Express Tribune, in its October 31 edition, pointed out a noticeable gap between government rhetoric and action. While the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) has historically emphasized the advantages of trade with India—advocating for a separation of trade from the Kashmir dispute—there remains skepticism about genuine governmental intent. The publication notes that just a few years ago, the PML-N criticized the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) government for similar proposals, reflecting a complex political landscape where trade discussions often become entangled with nationalistic sentiments.

The News International took a broader perspective on Pakistan's trade dynamics in its October 29 edition, highlighting that Pakistan's overall trade relationships in the region are significantly underdeveloped. The report points out that Pakistani exporters frequently favor Western markets, which, despite their value, incur high logistical costs. This focus on distant markets may not serve Pakistan's economic interests in the long run.

The overarching message from the media is clear: enhancing trade relations with regional neighbors, including Afghanistan and Iran, as well as exploring opportunities with Southeast Asian nations, could offer Pakistan a pathway to reduce costs and establish a more diversified trade network. By re-engaging with India, Pakistan could not only bolster its economic prospects but also contribute to greater stability and growth within South Asia as a whole.

In conclusion, as discussions around trade normalization with India gain momentum, the challenge remains for the Pakistani government to align its actions with its rhetoric. Emphasizing regional cooperation could pave the way for more sustainable economic growth, helping Pakistan leverage its geographic position to foster beneficial trade relationships in a rapidly changing global economy.







'Harassment, Intimidation'': India On Surveillance Of Officials In Canada

India's diplomatic relations with Canada have reached a new low, as the Indian government revealed on Saturday that some of its consular officials have been informed by the Canadian authorities of being under audio and video surveillance. The Ministry of External Affairs characterized this action as a "flagrant violation" of diplomatic conventions and protocols.

During a press briefing, Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal stated, "Some of our consular officials were recently informed by the Canadian government that they have been and continue to be under audio and video surveillance. Their communications have also been intercepted. We have formally protested to the Canadian government, as we deem these actions to be a flagrant violation of relevant diplomatic and consular conventions."

Jaiswal emphasized the challenging environment in which Indian diplomatic and consular personnel operate, stating that they already face threats from "extremism and violence." He further criticized Canada's justification of these actions, asserting that "by citing technicalities, the Canadian government cannot justify the fact that it is indulging in harassment and intimidation." He added that such actions only exacerbate tensions between the two countries and violate established diplomatic norms.

The revelation comes amid ongoing tensions and accusations between the two nations, highlighting the fragile state of their diplomatic ties. India has expressed its commitment to safeguarding the integrity and security of its diplomatic staff, insisting that Canada's actions are unacceptable and detrimental to international relations.

As the situation unfolds, both countries will need to navigate these complex diplomatic waters carefully, with the potential for further escalation if grievances are not addressed satisfactorily.





External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar to Visit **Australia and Singapore**

External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar is set to embark on a visit to Australia and Singapore from November 3 to 8, where he will engage with leaders from both nations and participate in significant diplomatic discussions. The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) announced that during his trip, Jaishankar will co-chair the 15th Foreign Ministers' Framework Dialogue (FMFD) alongside Australian Foreign Minister Penny Wong in Canberra.

Jaishankar's itinerary includes delivering the keynote address at the inaugural session of the 2nd Raisina Down Under, which will take place at the Australian Parliament House. The minister is also expected to have interactions with various stakeholders, including Australian leadership, parliamentarians, members of the Indian diaspora, business leaders, media representatives, and think tanks.

A highlight of Jaishankar's visit will be the inauguration of India's fourth consulate in Australia, which will take place in Brisbane. This move underscores the strengthening ties between India and Australia, particularly in light of the increasing momentum of the India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership (CSP).

The partnership has been a focal point for both countries, aimed at enhancing security and prosperity in the region. This commitment was emphasized during the second India-Australia 2+2 Foreign and Defence Ministerial Dialogue held in Delhi in November of the previous year, where both sides acknowledged the positive trajectory of their bilateral relations.



Surge in LPG and Jet Fuel Demand Reflects India's Economic Growth



icant rise compared to the same month last year, indicating strong demand driven by a growing economy. According to data released by public sector oil companies, LPG consumption surged by 7.5 per cent yearon-year during the festive period. Additionally, jet fuel demand also saw a modest increase of 2.5 per cent.

Petrol sales from the major oil companies—Indian Oil, Bharat Petroleum, and Hindustan Petroleum, which collectively hold over 90 per cent of the market share climbed to 3.1 million tonnes in October 2024, compared to 2.87 million tonnes in October 2023. This growth is supported by the rise in car, SUV, and two-wheeler sales across both urban and rural regions, reflecting increased consumer spending and mobility in a prospering economy.

The uptick in jet fuel consumption, which reached 6,47,700 tonnes in October 2024, aligns with a surge in air travel. This increase is propelled by the expanding middle class that is reaping the benefits of robust economic growth, leading to greater disposable income and

In October 2024, LPG consumption experienced a signif- more frequent travel. The aviation sector has seen consistent growth, evidenced by domestic airlines carrying 1.30 crore passengers in September 2024, marking a 6.38 per cent rise from the same period the previous year.

> On the other hand, diesel sales experienced a downturn, falling by 3.3 per cent. This decline is attributed to the extended monsoon season, which delayed the sowing period and, consequently, reduced diesel demand in the agricultural sector. The impact of monsoon rains on farming activities often directly influences the consumption of diesel, as it is a key fuel for farm machinery and irrigation.

> The data indicates a mixed picture for fuel consumption trends in India. While the demand for petrol and LPG has grown significantly, reflecting a thriving economy and increased consumer activity, the diesel segment faced challenges due to weather-related disruptions in the agricultural sector. Overall, the rise in fuel consumption, especially for petrol and jet fuel, showcases India's ongoing economic growth and the increasing mobility of its population.

India's power consumption rises amid strong growth



India's power consumption reached 140.47 billion units (BU) in October, reflecting a modest one percent increase compared to the same month last year, which had seen a substantial rise of over 22 percent. The consumption spike in October 2023, up from 113.94 BU in October 2022, was primarily driven by heightened demand from the industrial and agricultural sectors of the rapidly growing economy.

Despite this increase in consumption, peak power demand decreased to 219.22 gigawatts (GW) in October, following a record high of approximately 250 GW in May, largely due to summer heat. The International Energy Agency (IEA) noted that India is projected to experience one of the highest increases in energy demand globally over the next decade, driven by its economic size and escalating demands across all sectors.

India was the fastest-growing major economy in 2023, with a 7.8 percent increase in output, and is expected to become the world's third-largest economy by 2028. The IEA's World Energy Outlook forecasts that iron and steel production will grow by 70 percent by 2035, while cement output is anticipated to rise nearly 55 percent. Moreover, the stock of air conditioners is expected to grow more than fourfold, with electricity demand from these units projected to exceed Mexico's total consumption by 2035.

The IEA report also highlights that coal will continue to play a significant role in India's energy mix, with an addition of nearly 60 GW of coal-fired capacity by 2030, resulting in a 15 percent increase in coal-generated electricity. This growth occurs despite a significant expansion of solar PV capacity, as coal generation remains over 30 percent higher due to lower capacity factors for solar installations.

Concurrently, India is pushing forward with its green energy initiatives. The recently launched National Electricity Plan aims to achieve 500 GW of renewable energy capacity by 2030 and over 600 GW by 2032. This plan includes the development of storage systems and an extensive transmission network to support green hydrogen and ammonia production at coastal hubs.

Overall, the National Electricity Plan anticipates adding over 191,000 km of transmission lines and enhancing inter-regional transmission capacity, while also establishing cross-border interconnections with several neighboring countries, indicating a comprehensive strategy for addressing India's growing energy demands while transitioning to renewable sources.

GST collection rises 9% on domestic demand

India's Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenue for October exceeded ₹1.87 lakh crore, marking the second-highest monthly collection since the implementation of the tax regime in July 2017. This impressive figure, recorded at ₹1,87,346 crore, reflects robust domestic demand and improved compliance measures, suggesting a promising start to the second half of the fiscal year 2025.

The October collection represents an 8.9% year-on-year increase, surpassing the previous second-highest monthly collection of ₹1,87,035 crore achieved in April 2023. Notably, this growth comes despite facing global economic challenges and a slowdown in some key states, including Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, and Karnataka. Chhattisgarh, on the other hand, reported a slight contraction of 1% year-on-year, collecting ₹2,656 crore.

The highest GST collection to date was recorded in April 2024, amounting to ₹2.10 lakh crore. For October 2024, net GST revenue also saw a healthy



ing ₹1,68,041 crore, despite overall refunds totaling ₹19,306 crore. This translates to an annualized growth of 18.2%. Technological advancements have contributed significantly to this efficiency, with domestic refunds increasing by 42.8% from ₹7,352 crore in October 2023 to ₹10,498 crore in October 2024.

Experts suggest that the strong GST collection in October underscores the resilience of domestic demand. However, they caution that while GST revenues from domestic supplies demonstrated robust growth of nue growth from imports has diminished to less than 4%. This decline indicates the negative impact of global economic headwinds on the overall GST revenue landscape.

In conclusion, the strong performance of GST collections in October highlights the strength of India's domestic market while also signaling the need to navigate potential challenges posed by external economic factors. As the fiscal year progresses, maintaining this momentum will be crucial for sustaining economic growth.

Crude Oil Prices Rise Amid Iran-Israel **Tensions and Record US Production**

International crude oil prices saw a modest uptick in the escalating into full-scale warfare. previous session, buoyed by reports of Iran preparing a potential retaliatory strike against Israel from Iraq. Despite this geopolitical tension, record crude production levels in the US continue to weigh on prices ahead of upcoming US elections and a Federal Reserve meeting.

Brent crude futures increased by 29 cents, or 0.4 percent, closing at \$73.10 per barrel, while West Texas Intermediate (WTI) rose by 23 cents, or 0.3 percent, to settle at \$69.49. Both benchmarks experienced a brief surge of over \$2 a barrel during the session. However, both Brent and WTI recorded weekly declines of approximately four percent and three percent, respectively. In India, crude oil futures settled 2.71 percent higher at ₹5,981 per barrel on the multi-commodity exchange (MCX).

The uptick in oil prices comes amid reports from Axios indicating that Israeli intelligence believes Iran is poised to launch an attack on Israel from Iraq within days. Experts suggest that any Iranian response may be limited, akin to Israel's restrained actions in recent weeks, suggesting a focus on demonstrating strength rather than shape crude oil market dynamics.

The ongoing hostilities between Iran and Israel have been part of a larger conflict in the Middle East, intensified by recent fighting in Gaza. Previous Iranian air attacks on Israel, including incidents on October 1, 2024, and in April, have largely been repelled, causing minimal damage.

Iran, a key member of OPEC, produced about four million barrels per day (bpd) in 2023 and is projected to export approximately 1.5 million bpd in 2024, a slight increase from 1.4 million bpd in 2023. Iran's influence in the region is significant, as it supports several groups engaged in conflict with Israel, including Hezbollah in Lebanon and Hamas in Gaza.

Additionally, US officials have urged Lebanon to declare a unilateral ceasefire with Israel to facilitate stalled discussions aimed at ending hostilities with Hezbollah, although both sides have denied these claims. German tunneling giant Herrenknecht is currently grappling with significant customs clearance issues in China that are affecting its ability to deliver tunnel boring machines (TBMs) to India. This situation has garnered attention following a discussion between Indian Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal and German Vice Chancellor Robert Habeck, during which Goyal highlighted the delays in the procurement of TBMs from Herrenknecht, which are manufactured in China.

In a statement addressing inquiries from The Indian Express, a Herrenknecht spokesperson noted, "For several months now, we have been observing extraordinary circumstances in



the customs clearance processes for machines to be delivered from China to India. These issues are hindering us from fulfilling our delivery obligations as expected and, in some cases,

Saurabh Sharma shared the post, highlighting a significant price difference for the same cabin suitcase, claiming that iOS users are charged more than their Android counterparts.

In his post, Sharma included screenshots showing the product listed at varying prices on the Flipkart app, depending on whether it was accessed from an iOS or Android device. This sparked a flurry of reactions, with many users expressing disbelief and concern over the potential price discrimination. The collage quickly went viral, prompting discussions about fairness in pricing strategies among online retailers.

While Flipkart has yet to officially respond to the allegations, the situation underscores the need for transparency in pricing and the impact of technology on consumer experiences. As consumers become more aware of such discrepancies, companies may need to reevaluate their pricing strategies to avoid backlash and protect their reputation.


Apple Acquires Pixelmator: A Leap into High-End Photo Editing

Apple Inc. has announced its acquisition of Pixelmator, the creator of a popular high-end photo-editing app, further enhancing its software offerings. In a blog post published Friday, Pixelmator revealed that its Lithuania-based team would be joining Apple as part of the deal. Founded 17 years ago by brothers Saulius and Aidas Dailide, Pixelmator develops applications for Mac, iPad, and iPhone users.

The partnership between Apple and Pixelmator has been strong, with Apple frequently showcasing Pixelmator's software in its marketing

campaigns, including a recent iPad event. The design of Pixelmator's applications closely mirrors Apple's own user interface, reinforcing their compatibility and appeal to Apple customers. In their announcement, Pixelmator expressed excitement about the acquisition, stating, "We've been inspired by Apple since day one. Now, we'll have the ability to reach an even wider audience."

Pixelmator Pro, the company's flagship app, features advanced editing tools similar to those found in Adobe's Photoshop and Illustrator, including functionalities like layers and vector editing. The software is also integrated with various Apple technologies such as iCloud, Shortcuts, and the iPad's Pencil, making it a powerful tool for creatives.



This acquisition marks a significant move for Apple, as it has not offered a high-end photo editing app since discontinuing Aperture nearly a decade ago. With a growing portfolio of professional applications—including Final Cut Pro and Logic Pro—available on the iPad via subscription, the addition of Pixelmator aligns perfectly with Apple's strategy to cater to professional users.

While Pixelmator Pro is priced at \$50 for Mac users, a standard version for iPad and iPhone costs \$10. The company also offers a separate Photomator editing app compatible across Apple devices. Pixelmator has assured its users that there won't be any immediate changes to its applications, but further updates will be announced in the future, leaving many eager to see how this new chapter unfolds.

Peanut, The Squirrel With 537,000 Followers On Instagram



Peanut, a beloved squirrel who rose to internet fame with 537,000 Instagram followers, has been euthanized, according to New York authorities. The news comes after Peanut reportedly bit a government staffer during an intervention.

Rescued by New Yorker Mark Longo, Peanut was saved as a baby after his mother was killed by a car. Longo bottle-fed the young squirrel and attempted to release him into the wild, but after losing part of his tail, Peanut returned to Longo's care. Over the past seven years, Peanut became a social media star, captivating fans with adorable antics like nibbling on waffles and wearing tiny costumes, all shared on the Instagram account peanut_the_squirrel12.

In a heartfelt Instagram post following Peanut's death, Longo expressed his devastation, stating, "Internet, you WON. You took one of the most amazing animals away from me because of your selfishness." He lamented the loss of his "best friend," describing his shock, disbelief, and disgust at the situation.

The Chemung County Department of Health and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) confirmed in a statement that both Peanut and a raccoon residing with Longo were euthanized to test for rabies. The DEC had seized the animals on October 30, citing the potential risk of rabies exposure from keeping wild animals as pets. The statement revealed that a person involved in the investigation was bitten by Peanut, necessitating the euthanasia for rabies testing.

The DEC urged anyone who had come into contact with the animals to seek medical advice. In response to the tragic turn of events, Longo vowed to continue his fight for animal rights and called on his supporters to contribute to his legal fees and plans to establish an animal sanctuary. 

Chinese researchers develop Al model for military use

This week, Washington announced it is finalizing rules to restrict U.S. investment in artificial intelligence and other technology sectors in China that may pose a threat to national security. This announcement comes in light of new developments indicating that top Chinese research institutions, some linked to the People's Liberation Army (PLA), have utilized Meta's publicly available Llama model to create an AI tool for potential military applications.

According to three academic papers reviewed by Reuters, researchers from six Chinese institutions, including two under the PLA's Academy of Military Science (AMS), reported using an early version of Meta's Llama to develop a military-focused AI tool known as "ChatBIT." In a paper published in June, the researchers detailed how they took the Llama 13B large language model (LLM) and incorporated their own parameters to design ChatBIT, which is intended to gather and process intelligence and provide



reliable information for operational decision-making.

ChatBIT has been fine-tuned specifically for dialogue and question-answering tasks within the military context, as stated in the paper. Notably, the AI tool reportedly outperformed other models that were around 90% as capable as OpenAI's ChatGPT-4. However, the researchers did not clarify how they measured performance or whether ChatBIT has been deployed in active service.

Sunny Cheung, an associate fellow at the Jamestown Foundation specializing in China's emerging technologies, commented, "It's the first time there has been substantial evidence that PLA military experts in China have been systematically researching and trying to leverage the power of open-source LLMs, especially those of Meta, for military purposes."

The implications of this research are significant, prompting U.S. officials to reassess the potential risks associated with investments in AI technologies that could bolster military capabilities in China. As the geopolitical landscape evolves, the intersection of AI and national security remains a critical area of concern for policymakers.







India Trails New Zealand by 40 Runs at Lunch on **Day Two of Final Test**

India reached 195 for 5 at lunch on day two of the third and final Test against New Zealand, trailing by 40 runs. Resuming play at their overnight score of 86 for 4, Rishabh Pant and Shubman Gill emerged as key contributors to the Indian innings. Pant played a counter-attacking knock, bringing up his half-century with flair, while Gill remained solid at the crease, finishing the session on 70 not out.

Pant's aggressive approach was a highlight of the morning session. He quickly accelerated the scoring and was instrumental in rebuilding India's innings. However, his innings came to an abrupt end when he was trapped leg before wicket by Ish Sodhi in the 38th over, leaving India at 165 for 5. Despite the setback, Pant's score of 60 showcased his intent and ability to counter the New Zealand bowling attack.

Shubman Gill, meanwhile, displayed a composed batting performance, complementing Pant's aggression with stability. He reached his half-century with a mix of solid defense and timely boundaries, ensuring India stayed in the contest. The Indian batsmen capitalized on a few missed chances by the New Zealand fielders, who dropped critical catches that could have altered the course of the innings.

New Zealand, having scored 235 in their first innings, aimed to capitalize on their lead. Daryl Mitchell and Will Young were the top scorers for the visitors, with Mitchell making 82 and Young contributing 71 runs. India's bowlers, led by Ravindra Jadeja, who took 5 wickets for 65 runs, and Washington Sundar, who claimed 4 for 81, managed to bundle out New Zealand for 235 in 65.4 overs. As the teams head into the next phase of the game, India will be looking to build a solid partnership and take control of the innings, while New Zealand will aim to exploit any weaknesses and secure a commanding position.

Mohun Bagan SG's Withdrawal Recognized as Force Majeure



Kolkata-based Mohun Bagan Super Giant (MBSG) announced on November 2 that the Asian Football Confederation (AFC) has officially recognized the club's withdrawal from their AFC Champions League 2 match in Iran as a case of force majeure. The decision to forgo their scheduled match against Tractor FC on October 2 was made to ensure the safety and security of the players amid escalating tensions in the region.

The AFC acted swiftly after the club's withdrawal, initially pulling MBSG from the tournament while assessing the situation. The club communicated that, following their appeal, the AFC Competitions Committee acknowledged the legitimacy of their concerns regarding player safety unrest in Iran.

In a statement, Mohun Bagan SG clarified that on November 2, they received confirmation from the AFC that "penal consequences, as per clause 5.7 of AFC Champions League 2 Competition Regulations, shall not apply to Mohun Bagan SG." However, the club emphasized that despite this recognition, they would remain withdrawn from the ongoing tournament due to clauses 5.5 and 5.6 of the competition regulations.

The decision to avoid travel to Iran accused the AFC of "unequal treatwas influenced by the volatile conditions following missile strikes launched by Iran on Israel, which heightened security risks. The situ-

during a time of heightened political ation was exacerbated by the death of a prominent general of the Revolutionary Guard, leading to widespread mourning and unrest in the country. Players voiced their concerns about the risks associated with traveling to Iran during this turbulent period.

Veteran Indian tennis player Rohan Bopanna, alongside his Australian partner Matthew Ebden, faced a tough quarterfinal defeat at the Paris Masters in the men's doubles competition. The third-seeded duo battled for one hour and 46 minutes before succumbing to the Dutch-Croatian pair of Wesley Koolhof and Nikola Mektic, losing 6-7, 5-7 in a closely contested match on Friday.

The first set was fiercely competitive, with both teams showcasing their skills. Bopanna and Ebden fought hard, but despite having several opportunities, they couldn't convert on crucial points. The set ultimately went to a tiebreak, where Koolhof and Mektic displayed resilience, saving set points to clinch the set and take a 1-0 lead in the match.

The second set continued in the same vein, with neither team able to gain a significant advantage. However, the turning point came in the 12th game when Bopanna and Ebden suffered a setback due to a double fault, allowing Koolhof and Mektic to break serve and seal the match.

Ravindra Jadeja Reaches 50 Wickets in WTC Cycle



Star Indian all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja has etched his name in history by becoming the second Indian, after Ravichandran Ashwin, to take 50 wickets in a World Test Championship (WTC) cycle. Jadeja achieved this milestone during the third and final Test against New Zealand at the Wankhede Stadium in Mumbai, where he delivered a stunning performance with a four-wicket haul on Day 2.

Returning to form, Jadeja dismantled the New Zealand middle order, claiming the crucial wickets of Daryl Mitchell, Tom Blundell, Ish Sodhi, and Matt Henry. His efforts left India in a favorable position, enabling them to set a target after enduring defeats in the first two matches of the series, marking their first series loss on home soil in 12 years.

Notably, Jadeja's impressive wicket tally surpassed his previous WTC cycle performance, where he concluded with 47 wickets from 13 matches. As of now, he stands as the third-leading wicket-taker in the ongoing WTC cycle, trailing only Ashwin, who tops the list with 62 wickets, and Australian fast bowler Josh Hazlewood, who has taken 51 scalps.

Jadeja's bowling form comes as a significant boost for the Indian team as they prepare for their next assignments following the New Zealand series. He previously showcased his prowess in the first innings with a five-wicket haul, bringing his total for the match to nine wickets, putting him on the cusp of achieving his third 10-wicket haul in Test cricket.

As India eyes a redemption in the Test match, they find themselves facing a New Zealand lead of 143 runs. With ample time remaining in the match, confidence is high within the Indian camp to chase down the target. However, the visitors' bowling attack, particularly in spinning conditions, poses a significant challenge, testing India's batting resilience.


