

DCM Pawan Kalyan Met Union Home Minister Amit Shah to Discuss Key State Issues





TPN, New Delhi: Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan met Union Home Minister Amit Shah in a private meeting on Wednesday evening in New Delhi. This marks the first one-on-one meeting between Pawan Kalyan and Amit Shah since Kalyan assumed the role of Deputy Chief Minister in the state government.

CM Chandrababu Issues Stern Warning to Ministers Over Laxity



TPN, Amaravati: Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu expressed strong dissatisfaction with certain ministers, warning that many have yet to show the seriousness required for their roles. Following a cabinet meeting held yesterday, Naidu held a separate session with his ministers, during which he criticized those who have not adjusted their behavior despite repeated instructions. "The government is facing criticism due to the actions of certain officials and ministers who haven't abandoned their soft approach," he stated, urging ministers to adopt a more disciplined and responsible attitude.

Naidu also pointed out that some officials, who were previously criticized during the former government, continue to act without regard for improvement, drawing unnecessary scrutiny to the current administration.

In the same cabinet meeting, Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan highlighted the issue of offensive social media posts made by certain YSR Congress Party (YCP) leaders. He voiced frustration over the police's lack of action on complaints regarding these posts. Kalyan mentioned that some Superintendents of Police (SPs) remain unresponsive, even when approached directly. He expressed particular concern over police officers who allegedly favored Jagan Mohan Reddy's administration and continue to hold key positions.

He also noted the distressing impact of these posts on families, emphasizing that the government needs to take action to protect both public image and the well-being of its citizens.

Cabinet Approves Key Policies for Growth and Development



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, convened its fifth e-Cabinet meeting at the State Secretariat on Wednesday, approving a series of transformative policies and decisions aimed at boosting the state's infrastructure, economy, and welfare.

One of the most significant approvals was the Andhra Pradesh Drone Policy 4.0, which seeks to establish the state as a hub for drone technology. A drone development center will be set up in Kurnool, attracting investments of approximately Rs. 1,000 crores and creating direct employment for 15,000 people. The policy also aims to develop 100 drone manufacturing companies, 20 drone pilot training centers, and 50 skill development institutes, contributing to an expected revenue of Rs. 3,000 crores in the drone sector.



Ministers Urge CM Chandrababu to Expose Rushikonda Palace to the Public, Highlighting Misuse of Power

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: In a recent Andhra Pradesh Cabinet meeting, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu expressed shock over the lavish expenditure on the Rushikonda Palace in Visakhapatnam. The CM revealed that Rs. 60 lakh was spent on a single cupboard, and hundreds of crores were used for the construction's luxury elements, including furniture, flooring, and architecture. He called the palace an "Indra Bhavan" and stated that, in his 45 years of political experience, he had never witnessed such extravagant spending.

The remarks came after accusations from YS-RCP leader Jagan Mohan Reddy, who claimed that public funds had been misused for building personal luxuries. Tourism Minister Kandula Durgesh also criticized the palace, pointing out that the road leading to it was designed as a "royal" avenue and questioned the use of public resources for such grandeur.

During the meeting, several ministers urged the CM to show the palace to the poor, homeless, and farmers



in the state to expose the misuse of public funds. They criticized Jagan for advocating for the poor while constructing a lavish palace.

Chandrababu responded by agreeing that the issue needed attention and asked the ministers to come up with suggestions on how to utilize the Rushikonda building. The debate over the palace's construction has fueled growing tensions regarding the handling of public funds and has drawn sharp political reactions.

AP Cabinet Approves Key Policies to Boost Growth and Development – Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy briefed the media on several pivotal decisions taken by the Andhra Pradesh Cabinet, aimed at enhancing the state's economic and industrial growth. Highlighting the challenges of the past five years, Parthasarathy emphasized the administration's commitment to utilizing the state's natural resources effectively and driving development.

One of the significant announcements was the approval of the AP Drone Policy, which includes establishing a Drone Corporation and a drone hub in Kurnool. This initiative is expected to attract investments worth thousands of crores and revolutionize industries like agriculture, logistics, and surveillance, creating numerous job opportunities.

The Cabinet also approved the AP Data Centers Policy, targeting the creation of 250 additional data



centers, which will strengthen the state's IT infrastructure and attract tech companies. Along with this, the AP Semiconductor Manufacturer Policy was approved, aiming to establish semiconductor manufacturing units and enhance Andhra Pradesh's role in the global tech ecosystem.

In another move, a new law was approved to replace the Land Grabbing Act, imposing stringent penalties for land encroachment, with punishments ranging from 10 to 14 years in

prison. The Cabinet also sanctioned the release of 331 crores for pending NRGS works, easing financial burdens on rural development contrac-

Other approvals include amendments to the AP Goods and Services Tax Bill, the ratification of three excise ordinances, and the revival of the Kuppam Area Development Authority. The Cabinet also endorsed the direct payment of student fees to college accounts and approved land allotments to 311 industrialists, further boosting industrial development in the state.

Minister Parthasarathy clarified that there was no discussion in the Council of Ministers about Deputy CM Pawan Kalyan's remarks on Home Minister Anita. These decisions set a strong foundation for the state's future growth and technological advancement.

AP Govt Introduces New Standards for Quality Liquor Testing – Minister Kollu Ravindra

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Kollu Ravindra, the State Minister for Mines, Geology & Excise has announced the implementation of new testing standards aimed at ensuring the production of quality liquor for consumers. The government has introduced advanced testing procedures in Regional Excise Laboratories to modernize the quality assurance of alcoholic beverages.

Previously, only basic standards for ic products. Extra Neutral Alcohol (ENA) samples were tested, but the new approach incorporates advanced Gas Chromatography (GC) technology to enhance the accuracy of tests. The new testing procedure will evaluate nine parameters for blended alcohol and thirteen parameters for ENA, ensuring the quality and safety of alcohol-



Speaking about the modernization, Ravindra explained that the traditional testing process, which only focused on ethyl alcohol, acidity, aldehydes, methanol, and water combinations, has now expanded to include a wider range of quality measures. The new standards will

cover all major alcoholic beverages, including whiskey, brandy, vodka, gin, and rum, ensuring that these products comply with the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) and Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) guidelines.

The upgraded facilities at the Regional Probationary and Excise Laboratories in Vizag, Guntur, Chittoor, Kurnool, and Kakinada will conduct comprehensive checks to prevent chemical reactions and maintain the health and safety of alcohol users. Kollu Ravindra emphasized that these reforms are part of the government's ongoing commitment to promoting the health care of alcohol consumers, ensuring that the liquor industry meets the highest standards of quality and safety.

AP Cabinet Approves Drone Policy Aiming for ₹1000 Crores Investment and Job Creation

In the Information Technology and Electronics sector, the Cabinet approved the Andhra Pradesh Data Center Policy 4.0, aiming to add 200 MW of data center capacity and position the state as a leading destination for AI-driven data embassies and data center parks. Similarly, the Andhra Pradesh Semiconductor and Display Fab Policy was introduced to attract foreign investments in the semiconductor industry, offering subsidies up to 30% for companies involved in semiconductor manufacturing.

On the legislative front, the Cabinet approved the Andhra Pradesh Land Grabbing (Prohibition) Bill-2024, which introduces severe punishments for imprisonment. This bill seeks to protect government lands and prevent illegal land encroachments.

The Cabinet also moved to address long-pending payments for rural development works, approving Rs. 331 crores for contractors involved in projects from 2014-2019. Additionally, an amendment to the Andhra Pradesh Public Employment (Regulation of Age of Superannuation) Act was passed, increasing the retirement age for judicial officers from 60 to 61 years.

Further decisions included the renovation of the Kuppam Area Development Authority and the creation of

land grabbers, including 10-14 years of the Pithapuram Area Development Authority to facilitate regional economic growth. The Cabinet also approved various amendments related to fee reimbursements and health services, including the conversion of the Pithapuram Community Health Center into a 100-bed regional hospital.

Minister Anagani Criticizes YCP Leaders for Alleged Land Grabs

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Andhra Pradesh Revenue Minister Anagani Satya Prasad has described the new Andhra Pradesh Land Grabbing Act-2024 as a "great milestone" in the state's history. Speaking to the media following a recent cabinet meeting, he emphasized that the new law would address widespread concerns about land grabbing, especially alleged encroachments by YCP leaders during their ten-

The state cabinet, led by Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, approved the AP Land Grabbing Act-2024, replacing the earlier AP Land Grabbing Prohibition Act of 1982. In their discussions, ministers highlighted the increase in land grab incidents under the YCP government, with reports suggesting that many public and private lands had been seized indiscriminately. Minister Anagani noted that "thousands of complaints" had been received from victims, who described their property as vulnerable to predatory encroachment.

"This Act will make trains run in the hearts of the land grabbers," said Minister Anagani, in a pointed remark directed at those involved in illegal land



occupation. The new law, he explained, provides for strict penalties: offenders can face imprisonment of 10 to 14 years and heavy fines. Additionally, any unlawfully acquired property will be subject to confiscation by the state.

To ensure efficient legal recourse, the government plans to establish a special court to handle land-grabbing cases. Victims will also have the option to either approach the court directly or file complaints with a dedicated committee headed by the district collector.

The new legislation, which applies to all types of land in the state, aims to restore public confidence by imposing severe consequences on those engaging in land encroachment and protecting the rights of property owners across Andhra Pradesh.

MLA Somireddy Accuses Aurobindo of Major Scandal in 108 Ambulance Service

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: MLA Somireddy Chandramohan Reddy has leveled serious allegations against Aurobindo Pharma, accusing the company of massive mismanagement and corruption in handling the 108 ambulance services under the YSR Congress Party (YCP) government. Speaking to the media on Wednesday, he claimed that Aurobindo's alleged negligence led to the loss of innocent lives due to delayed emergency response.

Reddy criticized the company for failing to uphold the "golden hour" principle critical in emergency medical care. He stated that the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) had previously highlighted Aurobindo's shortcomings, yet no action was taken by the YCP administration. He further demanded that a murder charge under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) be filed against Aurobindo's owners, alleging that their negligence and greed cost many lives.



According to Reddy, the previous Telugu Desam Party (TDP) government contracted the GVK organization to manage the 108 ambulances from 2011 until 2021. Under GVK, the service charged Rs. 1.31 lakh per month per ambulance. However, after YCP awarded the contract to Aurobindo, costs reportedly surged, with Rs. 2.21

lakh being paid per ambulance. Reddy claimed this inflated expense burdened the state's finances by an additional Rs. 800 crores.

He also called for a comprehensive inquiry into the 108 ambulance services, alleging widespread misuse of funds and irregularities in trip registrations. Reddy criticized A2 Vijayasai Reddy and other YCP leaders for issuing government orders (GOs) that favored Aurobindo, facilitating what he described as looting of public resources. He demanded that the 108 services be transferred under the direct supervision of the Health and Family Welfare Department to prevent further mismanagement and ensure accountability.

Reddy's statements have intensified scrutiny on the government's handling of emergency services, amplifying calls for transparency and accountability in public health administration.

AP Congress Protests Power Tariff Hike, Demands Immediate Rollback TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh Congress Commit-

tee (APCC) held a protest against the proposed power tariff hike, condemning the state government's decision to impose an additional financial burden on the people. Led by APCC President Y S Sharmila Reddy, Congress workers symbolically held up lanterns at Dharna Chowk in Vijayawada to criticize the government's alleged failure to "light the way" for the public.

Sharmila denounced the Rs. 17,000 crore electricity surcharge adjustment, arguing that it is the outcome of mismanagement by the previous YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) government, exacerbated by the policies of the current ruling alliance. "The so-called 'adjustment' in power tariffs will cripple households across the state," she stated, emphasizing that people are already burdened by an additional Rs. 6,000 crore surcharge, with concerns of another Rs. 11,000 crore to follow.

In her address, Sharmila accused the ruling parties of breaking their promises made in opposition, where they had vowed to lower electricity charges. "Now, barely five months into power, they're imposing even harsher burdens on the people," she remarked.

Sharmila also urged TDP leader N. Chandrababu Naidu to press the BJP-led central government for funds to ease the impact of the surcharge on Andhra Pradesh. The APCC further demand-



ed a thorough investigation into alleged irregularities in power procurement and distribution.

"The Congress calls for an immediate rollback of this surcharge adjustment and insists on refunds for people unfairly charged these additional fees," Sharmila concluded. The protest reflects growing public discontent and a call for transparency in state energy management.

Roja Criticizes AP Home Minister Anitha Over Tirupati Assault Case

Andhra Pradesh: YCP leader and former minister, Roia, has strongly criticized Andhra Pradesh Home Minister Anita for allegedly mishandling a sensitive case involving the sexual assault of a Class X girl in Tirupati. Expressing deep sorrow over the incident, Roja took to social media to voice

her frustration and demanded accountability from state authorities.

Addressing the issue publicly, Roja questioned whether those in power were genuinely addressing the father's pleas for justice. "Honorable Home Minister Anita Garu and SP Garu, place your hand on your heart and introspect," Roja said in her message. She condemned what she described as an attempt to downplay and sidetrack the case, questioning why the administration seemed to be withholding facts rather than pursuing swift justice.



anguish of the girl's father, who is reportedly seeking severe punishment for the perpetrators. "If the father of that child is begging for justice, can't you feel his pain?" Roja asked, appealing to officials to acknowledge the victim's family's suffering.

The incident has sparked outrage, with calls for thorough investigation and strict action against those responsible. Roja's criticism reflects growing public concern over the handling of the case and has intensified calls for transparency and accountability within the state government.

Nandigam Suresh Denied **Bail in High Court in 2020** Velagapudi Incident

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Former YSR Congress Party (YCP) MP Nandigam Suresh faced a setback in the Andhra Pradesh High Court as his petition for bail was dismissed in connection with a 2020 incident in Velagapudi that resulted in the death of a woman named Mariamma.

The case dates back to 2020, when a clash erupted between two communities in Velagapudi, Tullur mandal. During the conflict, both groups reportedly pelted stones, leading to the tragic death of Mariamma. Her family subsequently lodged a complaint at the Tullur police station, sparking an investigation into the incident. Suresh was later implicated as the 78th accused in the case by police.



Suresh initially sought bail from the Guntur court, which rejected his request. He then approached the High Court, hoping for a favorable decision. However, after hearing the petition, the High Court dismissed his appeal for bail yesterday, leaving him disappointed.

This dismissal underscores the judicial stance on the case, as authorities continue their probe into the 2020 clash and the associated allegations.

N.T.R. District Police Launches Innovative Locked House Monitoring System to Enhance Security



TPN, Vijayawada: In Vijayawada N.T.R. District Police Commissioner's office launched the innovative Locked House Monitoring System (LHMS) aimed at enhancing home security and reducing thefts in the area. The initiative was unveiled by City Police Commissioner Shri S. V. Raja Shekhara Babu IPS, along with Crime DCP Mr. Tirumaleshwar Reddy IPS and other senior officials.

In many cases, people leave their homes locked while traveling to other villages for work or personal reasons,

making their homes vulnerable to theft. Recognizing this, the LHMS system has been introduced to monitor these locked houses. When individuals travel, they can register their details via the LHMS mobile app, available for download from the Google Play Store, or by calling the police directly. Once registered, the police will install Wi-Fi enabled surveillance cameras at the house free of charge.

These cameras are connected to the control room, where any suspicious activity triggers an alarm. This allows

the police to respond promptly and prevent crimes by catching thieves in the act.

During the event, Police Commissioner Raja Shekhara Babu emphasized the importance of utilizing the LHMS app for the safety and security of homes. He encouraged residents to take advantage of this service, noting that it will provide immediate police intervention if any unauthorized person enters a registered property.

For more details and to avail of the service, people can download the LHMS app from the Google Play Store or contact the police at 9440906878. This new system is expected to strengthen the security framework in Vijayawada and provide peace of mind to residents, ensuring swift action against crime.

YCP Influence in Coalition Govt Sparks Controversy Over Police Cases Against Alliance Leaders

TPN, V.V.S.Madhubabu: Tensions have escalated in the Mylavaram constituency following allegations that TDP and Janasena activists are being unfairly targeted by the ruling YCP in the coalition government. Activists claim that the police, under the influence of YCP leaders, are filing illegal cases against opposition party members, causing unrest within the region.

A prime example of this alleged bias is the behavior of B. Mohan Rao, Sub-Inspector of the Reddigudem Police Station, who activists accuse of turning a blind eye to illegal activities by YCP supporters. They argue that while TDP-affiliated JCBs were fined for transporting soil for road construction projects in Rangapuram, similar activities involving YCP vehicles and JCBs went unchecked.

The activists point to the registration of cases against TDP vehicles despite having proper permits for their activities, while YCP vehicles allegedly engage in illegal soil transport with no repercussions. Furthermore, allegations are being made against SSI Mohan Rao for aiding illegal activities, including the transport of illegal ration rice in the region.

TDP activists have also raised concerns about the removal of photos of MLA Vasantha Venkata Krishna Prasad and claims of harassment targeting party members. They assert that despite the change in government, the harassment continues with police actions, including the reopening of old cases and the threat of rowdy sheets.

TDP leaders say that the police are being used as a tool to target them, with accusations that the ruling party is leveraging its influence to suppress opposition voices and intimidate activists. The ongoing tensions have led to frustration among TDP members, who feel that justice is being selectively applied under the current administration.

Vijayawada Municipal Corporation Takes Steps to Prevent Waste Dumping in Canals

TPN, Vijayawada: Vijayawada Municipal Corporation Commissioner, Dhyanchandra, has emphasized the need for strict action against the dumping of waste in the city's canals. On Wednesday morning, the Commissioner visited the harbor canal to assess the situation and examine the sewage disposal in the area, taking a boat ride to closely inspect the condition of the canal.

Dhyanchandra directed the concerned authorities to ensure that no waste, including plastic and other debris, is discarded into the canals. He called for continuous monitoring of the canals to prevent the growth of vegetation such as horseshoes, which can obstruct the flow of water. The officials have also been instructed to carry out regular cleaning operations to maintain the cleanliness of the canals.

The Commissioner stressed that the health of the canals directly impacts the city's drainage system and overall sanitation. He urged citizens to avoid the practice of dumping waste in the waterways, which could lead to serious environmental and health issues.

The Municipal Corporation has vowed to take further measures to keep the city's waterways free of pollutants and to ensure sustainable practices for waste disposal.

98.2% of Insurance Claims Settled in NTR District, Final Claims to Be Addressed Soon



TPN, NTR District: The settlement of insurance claims for flood-affected vehicles and property in NTR District has reached an impressive 98.20 percent, with the remaining claims expected to be settled soon. District Collector in charge, Dr. Nidhi Meena, emphasized the need for insurance companies to expedite the resolution of the few pending claims. Dr. Meena, alongside DRO M. Lakshmi Narasimha, held a review meeting with representatives of insurance companies at

the District Collectorate on Wednesday. During the meeting, they discussed the registered, settled, and outstanding claims. A total of 15,459 claims were filed, including 12,638 motor vehicle claims and 2,821 property claims. Of these, 605 claims were withdrawn, and 325 were rejected, leaving 14,529 net claims.

The Collector in charge highlighted that 98.20 percent of claims had been resolved, with work ongoing for the remaining cases. However, issues such as the scarcity of spare parts for electric vehicles and challenges with attachment loans and RC cancellations have delayed the final settlements. Dr. Meena reiterated that the Chief Minister had paid special attention to the timely settlement of insurance claims and urged insurance companies to speed up the final process. Motor vehicle inspector R. Praveen, GM-DIC B. Sambaiah, and other insurance representatives attended the meeting.

Transfer of Estate Officers in Rythu Bazars Sparks Controversy in NTR District

TPN, V.V.S.Madhubabu: The recent memo issued by the Agriculture Marketing Department regarding the transfer of Estate Officers (EOs) in the Rythu Bazars in NTR District has raised eyebrows, with accusations of political interference and allegations of financial dealings surrounding the transfers.

The Agriculture Department's directive allows Estate Officers who have served at the same Rythu Bazar for two years to apply for transfers. However, the process has been clouded by MLA recommendations and allegations of under-the-table payments, with some claiming that transfers are only granted to those who can offer financial incentives.

In N.T.R. District, a total of 11 Estate Officers (EOs) are currently assigned to 12 Rythu Bazaars. These officers include Ramana in Jaggayapet, Ravi in Nandigama, Ajay in Kanchikacharla, Chittibabu in Mailavaram and Tiruvuru, Balaji in Bhavanipuram, Ramesh in Kedareshwarpet, Koteswara Rao in Ajit Singh Nagar, Uday Kiran in Payakapuram and GS Raju Road, Srinivas Shastri on Sambamurthy Road, John Victor in Krishna Lanka, and Karunakar in Patamata and APIIC Colony.

The Agriculture Department has recently issued a memo allowing for transfers of EOs who have been in their current positions for two years. However, there is a growing concern as transfers seem to be influenced by MLA recommendations. This has raised questions about transparency,



with some alleging that financial transactions are involved in securing these transfers. Despite these issues, the transfer process continues to be scrutinized by the public and political leaders.

While the monthly salary of Rythu Bazar EOs is relatively low, with most officers earning around ₹25,000, there are rumors that they are expected to pay between ₹2-5 lakhs for a transfer to a preferred location. Such claims have led to suspicions about illegal income and corruption within the transfer process. The controversy surrounding the transfers has prompted questions about the integrity of the system, with critics arguing that the Rythu Bazar EO transfers are being used as a way to enrich those involved rather than focusing on the interests of the public and farmers.

Officials in the department, however, maintain that the transfer process is based on established guidelines and that all necessary recommendations are followed.

IT Raids on Shrimp Trader's Properties in Nagayalanka Amid Alleged Ties to YCP Leader

TPN, Vijayawada: In a dramatic turn of events, Income Tax (IT) officials conducted simultaneous raids on multiple properties of prominent shrimp trader Chennu Lakshmana Rao in Nagayalanka, Krishna district. The raids targeted his residence, ice factory, and other business establishments, sparking widespread attention.

Business circles in the region speculate that these actions are connected to Lakshmana Rao's associations with Granthi Srinivas, a renowned shrimp exporter and influential leader from the Yuvajana Sramika Rythu Congress Party (YCP). Srinivas has been a significant figure in the local business and political landscapes, and his alleged ties with Lakshmana Raomay have triggered the raids, according to sources.

The operation has left the local community and business sectors



in a state of uncertainty, with many questioning the motive behind the IT department's surprise actions. While the authorities have yet to provide further details on the matter, the raids are being closely watched, especially in the context of the ongoing political dynamics in the region. As investigations unfold, the impact on local businesses and political affiliations remains a key area of focus. The IT department's move has raised eyebrows, with many awaiting clarification on whether the raids are politically motivated or linked to financial irregularities within Lakshmana Rao's enterprises.

Gandhi Hill to be Developed as a Major **Tourist Destination -MLA Sujana** Chaudhary



TPN, Vijayawada: In a bid to enhance tourism in the region, MLA Sujana Chaudhary has announced plans to develop Gandhi Hill, a memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi, as a major tourist attraction. Speaking at the inauguration of the Gandhi Hill Planetarium and Nakshatra Exhibition Hall on Wednesday, Sujana Chaudhary expressed his excitement over the modernization of the planetarium, which had been closed for 10 years. The modernization, which cost Rs 82 lakh, aims to promote science and technology and raise awareness about space and planetary motions among students.

The MLA shared that he will soon meet with Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) officials to discuss further development plans for Gandhi Hill, with the goal of making it a prominent tourist spot. Several local leaders, including Zonal Commissioner Ramesh Keertana, CM HO Incharge Suresh Babu, and Technical Adviser Narayanamurthy Kotami, were present at the event.

Borugadda Anil Remanded for 14 Days in Assault and Attack Cases in Thullur



TPN, Guntur: Two cases were registered against Borugadda Anil, a local figure in Thullur of Guntur district, during the recent elections. The Tullur police presented Anil in the Mangalagiri court today, where he was charged with assaulting a flying squad, attacking an Assistant Sub-Inspector (ASI), and allegedly attacking individuals from Bihar working at a local dhaba.

The charges filed against Anil include Sections 353 (Assault or criminal force to deter public servant from discharge of his duty), 341 (Punishment for wrongful restraint), and 390 (Robbery) of the Indian Penal Code.

Following the hearing, the Mangalagiri court remanded Borugadda Anil to 14 days of judicial custody. Authorities have taken this action as part of their ongoing investigations into the incidents related to election-related violence and disturbances in the region.

The case has sparked local discussions, especially regarding the involvement of political figures and the escalation of tensions during the election period.

Venkatrami Reddy Has Been Arrested for Posting an Objectionable Photo of CM Chandrababu

TPN, Guntur: A person named Ven- According to the DSP, the photo of the katrami Reddy has been arrested for posting an objectionable and morphed photo of Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu on social media. The incident was reported by Guntur DSP Jayaram Prasad, who confirmed that a case was filed against Reddy under relevant sections for spreading offensive content.

CM was altered and shared on Facebook, leading to a swift police investigation. Venkatrami Reddy was arrested and produced before the court, which remanded him to judicial custody for 14 days. DSP Prasad also issued a stern warning to the public, stating that strict action will be taken against individuals involved in posting objectionable content on social media.

Action Taken Against Kadapa SP Harshavardhan Raju for Negligence

TPN, Kadapa: Andhra Pradesh government has become serious about the controversial episode involving YCP social media activist Varra Ravinder Reddy. Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, along with Ministers Lokesh and Anitha, expressed their anger over the actions of Kadapa SP Harshvardhan Raju in this matter. The government is preparing to take action against the Kadapa SP, signaling its seriousness regarding the issue.



The situation arose

when Varra Ravinder Reddy, an activist involved in spreading misinformation on social media against alliance leaders, was arrested by the Chinnachau police in Pulivendula. He was brought to Kadapa and held at the Kadapa Taluk police station. However, despite being in police custody, the Rajampet police later found that Ravinder Reddy had been released after receiving a 41A notice, prompting concerns about negligence and mishandling.

The Kadapa SP, Harshvardhan Raju, is under intense scrutiny following reports that Ravinder Reddy was released under the influence of YCP MP Avinash Reddy. This sparked an internal investigation led by Kurnool Range DIG Koya Praveen, who is meeting with SP Harshvardhan Raju to understand the circumstances surrounding the incident.

In response to public outcry, the state government has decided to transfer Kadapa SP Harshvardhan Raju and suspend another CI from the district. Allegations surfaced that YCP leader Varra Ravinder Reddy, who is reportedly close to former Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy's family, was treated leniently despite multiple complaints regarding his posts on social media. The government has taken swift action, and further official orders regarding the SP's transfer are expected soon.

The Fragile Power of American Democracy and Soft Power in a Changing World

As the 2024 US presidential election nears its conclusion, Donald Trump appears poised to win, having secured crucial battleground states like Pennsylvania, North Carolina, and Georgia. With Kamala Harris staring at defeat, the election results have already sparked widespread debate about the future of American democracy. Despite over 66 million Americans having voted early, claims of voter fraud and election rigging are circulating on social media, echoing the "Stop the Steal" movement from 2020. This has led many to believe that, if Trump loses, he might once again reject the results.

For many, this reflects a troubling decline in the democratic ideals that once made the US a global beacon of freedom and stability. The US, once the gold standard of peaceful transitions of power, now faces deepening political polarization, eroded trust in government, and a fractured public sphere. As an Indian observer of elections, I am struck by the contrast—while India's democracy has its flaws, it remains remarkably resilient, with smooth transitions of power being a common expectation.

Yet, even amid these internal challenges, America's global influence endures, largely through its soft power. The US presidential election is not just a national event; its outcome has far-reaching implications for global geopolitics. Ukraine, European democracies, and global allies all have their eyes on the race, hoping for a Harris win and the promise of stability. In contrast, Trump's "America First" approach, which upended international relations and fostered nationalist movements abroad, raises concerns about the future of global partnerships.

Historically, the US has prided itself on being a champion of democratic values: the rule of law, individual rights, and freedom of speech. This ideal of American exceptionalism has been exported globally, particularly through Hollywood, music, and media, which have carried the American Dream to every corner of the world. From films like *Captain America* to the global influence of artists like Michael Jackson, American culture has become synonymous with ideals of freedom and opportuni-



American soft power is also evident in its world-class educational institutions, technological innovations, and digital platforms, which have reshaped communication and fostered global connections. With companies like Apple, Google, and Facebook shaping modern life, America's influence extends far beyond its borders.

However, the US now faces growing competition from other nations, particularly India, which has seen its own cultural and soft power reach new heights. From the global celebration of Diwali to the worldwide popularity of Bollywood, India's cultural exports are making a mark. The rise of Indian cinema, in particular, is undeniable, with Bollywood stars like Shah Rukh Khan becoming global icons. As India's soft power grows, it could one day challenge the US's dominance in this area.

Despite its current position as the world's most influential exporter of soft power, the US is at a crossroads. Its democracy, once an inspiring example for the world, is under strain. The future of American soft power, and its ability to continue leading the global stage, hinges on how it navigates its internal divisions and upholds the values that once made it a beacon of freedom. As the 2024 election results unfold, the world will be watching to see if America can regain its moral authority and maintain its status as a global leader.

The Khalistan Issue: A Complex **Security Challenge Misrepresented in Western Media**



The ongoing Khalistan issue has long been a troubling picture. The demand for a separate sensitive and complex matter for India, involving a demand for a separate Sikh state. However, Western media coverage, such as a recent article in *The New York Times* by Anupreeta Das titled "Sikh Activists See It as Freedom. India Calls It Terrorism," often portrays the Indian government's actions against Khalistani separatists in a simplistic and skewed manner. The article suggests that India's response to the Khalistan movement is authoritarian, driven by Hindu nationalist agendas, and disconnected from genuine security concerns. Such portrayals not only lack nuance but also fail to recognize the gravity of the threats posed by the Khalistani movement, both historically and in the present day.

Das argues that the Indian government has used heavy-handed tactics against Sikhs advocating for Khalistan, labeling them as terrorists without acknowledging the movement's legitimate grievances. She contends that the Indian authorities have used the rhetoric of terrorism to suppress what she describes as a call for freedom. While these claims might resonate with some voices within the Sikh diaspora, they fail to account for the broader and more disturbing aspects of the Khalistan movement, which have included violence, extremism, and support for separatist terror in the past.

A deeper dive into the history of the Khalistan movement reveals a far more complicated and

Sikh state reached its peak during the 1980s when militants, led by figures like Jarnail Singh Bhindranwale, escalated violence in Punjab, leading to thousands of deaths. The 1984 anti-Sikh riots, which followed the assassination of Prime Minister Indira Gandhi by her Sikh bodyguards, further fueled the separatist cause, leading to widespread terror across the region. The Indian government's subsequent military action, Operation Blue Star, aimed at removing militants from the Golden Temple in Amritsar, was a direct response to the armed insurrection.

Although the Khalistan movement has lost much of its momentum since the 1990s, there remains a faction of radical elements, both within India and among the Sikh diaspora, that continue to advocate for separatism. India's ongoing measures against these groups are not mere political suppression; they are responses to the real and present security threats posed by extremist factions that continue to engage in violent acts and terrorist activities.

The *New York Times* article fails to account for this historical and ongoing context, instead focusing mainly on the perspective of Khalistani activists without presenting a balanced view of the situation. By doing so, it risks oversimplifying a complex issue and misrepresenting India's actions as overly harsh, rather than as legitimate responses to security threats rooted in decades of violence and extremism.

Bonded Labour in Karnataka: A Continuing Struggle Despite Legal Progress

Nearly five decades after the Bonded Labour Abolition Act of 1976 was passed to eradicate one of India's most exploitative practices, bonded labour remains a persistent issue in several regions of the country. Bengaluru, along with at least 10 other districts in Karnataka, continues to witness the exploitation of individuals under the bondage system, undermining the progress made through legislation. Despite the law, which was meant to end this practice and protect vulnerable communities, bonded labour is still a harsh reality for many, particularly in rural areas.

The Bonded Labour Abolition Act was introduced to free individuals who were forced to work under oppressive conditions for little or no pay, often in a state of debt bondage. According to the law, any form of bonded labour was made illegal, and individuals involved in it were to be rehabilitated with government support. However, in Karnataka, a state known for its urbanization and eco-

nomic development, this social ill continues to affect marginalized communities such as Dalits, tribals, and lower-caste groups.

In Bengaluru and other parts of Karnataka, people are still subjected to this form of servitude, particularly in sectors like construction, agriculture, domestic work,



and brick kilns. Many bonded workers, including women and children, are trapped in exploitative conditions, working for long hours without pay, and in some cases, under threat of violence or physical harm. They are often forced to work for their employers in exchange for loans or advances that they can never repay, thus perpetuating the cycle of exploitation.

One major issue contributing to the persistence of bonded labour is the lack of enforcement of existing laws. Despite being illegal, bonded labour is often difficult to detect, as it operates in the shadows of informal labour markets. Additionally, corruption, inadequate law enforcement, and a lack of awareness among the affected communities hinder efforts to combat the practice effectively.

Moreover, while the government has made efforts to rehabilitate victims of bonded labour, the support structures in place are often insufficient. Many individuals rescued from bonded labour face difficulty in adjusting to life outside the system due to the lack of skills, education, and social support.

ISRO to Launch EU's Proba-3 Sun **Observation Mission in December**

India's space agency, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), is set to launch the European Union's Proba-3 Sun Observation Mission in December 2024. The mission, which aims to study the Sun's faint corona close to its solar rim, will be launched aboard ISRO's PSLV-XL rocket from the Sriharikota launch site. This collaboration between ISRO and European space scientists will provide valuable insights into the Sun's atmosphere.

Speaking at the Indian Space Conclave 3.0 in New Delhi, Dr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister of State for Science & Technology, highlighted the impor-

tance of this mission. He noted that Proba-3 will include two satellites that will work together to create a 144-meter-long solar coronagraph, a specialized instrument that will allow scientists to study the Sun's elusive corona. The Sun's corona is difficult to observe due to the over-



whelming brightness of its solar disk, but the Proba-3 mission will enable precise observations with unprecedented proximity and detail.

Singh emphasized the significance of the mission, calling it the "world's first precision formation flying mission." The Proba-3 will allow scientists to study the Sun's corona with unparalleled clarity, offering new insights into solar phenomena.

During his address at the conclave, Dr. Singh also discussed India's growing space sector, which, until recently, was largely restricted to government agencies. With the launch of the 2023 New Space Policy, the Indian space sector has opened up to public-private partnerships, driving innovation and growth. He also spoke about ambitious goals for India's space future, including the establishment of the Bharatiya Antariksha Station (BAS) by 2035 and the landing of an Indian astronaut on the Moon by 2040.

The minister further highlighted the role of space technology in various sectors, from navigation and satellite imaging to terrain mapping. These technologies are also instrumental in the development of smart cities, enhancing urban planning and infrastructure.

India aims to increase its share in the global space economy from 2% to 10% in the coming years, positioning itself as a major player in the space industrt.

Disillusioned with the political establishment, Hamade views her vote for Stein as more than a protest. She hopes to help Stein reach five percent of the national popular vote, a threshold that could provide the Green Party with federal funding and potentially challenge the dominance of the two-party system in US politics.

Dearborn, known for its significant Middle Eastern population, largely backed President Joe Biden in 2020. However, recent polling indicates a shift away from the Democratic Party among Muslim and Arab-American voters, driven by frustrations over US foreign policy, particularly in the Middle East. Stein, a left-wing Jewish physician, has gained support from voters like Muhammad Hijazi, a 28-year-old engineer who identifies as a "single-issue voter." Hijazi, disillusioned with both the Democrats and Republicans, believes Stein is the only candidate opposing "genocide" and offering a more principled stance on Middle East peace.

China Calls for 'Peaceful Coexistence' As Trump Set For Win

As the US presidential election approaches, China finds itself closely watching the race, knowing that the outcome will have significant global implications. Whether it's Democrat Kamala Harris or Republican Donald Trump who wins, the broader trajectory of US-China relations is expected to remain adversarial. Netanyahu Fires Defence Minister Yoav Gallant Amid Gaza Conflict Tensions

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu dismissed his defence minister, Yoav Gallant, on Tuesday following mounting public disagreements over Israel's military operations in Gaza. Gallant, a key figure in Israel's tough stance on Hezbollah, had recently called for a ceasefire and advocated for a hostage release deal in Gaza, signaling a rift between him and Netanyahu over the handling of the war.

In a statement, Netanyahu's office explained that trust between the two leaders had eroded over the past few months, leading to Gallant's ousting. The Prime Minister appointed Israel Katz, a former top diplomat, as the new defence minister. Gideon Saar was appointed to replace Katz as the country's foreign minister.

Gallant, who had served as Israel's defence chief since 2022, expressed that despite his dismissal, Israel's security would remain his life's mission. His firing comes amid an intensifying war in Gaza, which was triggered by Hamas's deadly attack on Israel on October 7 last year, killing 1,206 Israelis, mostly civilians. In retaliation, Israeli forces have launched a brutal military campaign in Gaza, which, according to the Gaza Health Ministry, has resulted in 43,391 Palestinian deaths, most of them civilians.

Meanwhile, the conflict has spilled over into Lebanon and Syria. Israeli forces have conducted air raids across southern Lebanon and Syria, targeting Hezbollah militants and weapons storage facilities. In Lebanon, Israeli airstrikes on the coastal town of Jiyeh killed one person and injured 20, while Hezbollah launched rockets and drones into northern Israel. The violence has claimed at least 1,964 lives in Lebanon since Hezbollah joined the conflict in late September.



The **Nifty Bank** index stood at 52,289.75, up by 82.50 points or 0.16%, while the **Nifty Midcap 100** index surged to 56,589.90, a gain of 474.45 points or 0.85%. The **Nifty Smallcap 100** index was also in the green at 18,651.70, gaining 148.25 points or 0.80%.

In the Sensex pack, top gainers included HCL Tech, ICICI Bank, Infosys, Bajaj Finserv, Bajaj Finance, Tech Mahindra, Maruti Suzuki, Sun Pharma, and Tata Steel, Hindustan Unilever, Kotak same day.

Mahindra Bank, Tata Motors, and SBI were among the top losers.

Market experts observed that the sharp rebound in the market on Tuesday suggested a possible halt to the downward trend witnessed in previous days. "The fact that the rebound is being led by fundamentally strong large banking stocks is significant and could indicate the continuation of the positive trend," they said.

The experts further noted that while the US elections may create shortterm noise in the markets, it will be the economic fundamentals that will drive the market direction in the coming weeks.

In Asia, stock markets in Jakarta, Shanghai, and Tokyo were trading in the green, while seoul, Bangkok, and Hong Kong were in the red. The US stock market also ended on a positive note, following the election results.

Oil falls on stock build, firm dollar as Trump win projected



Crude oil prices dropped by 2.5% on Wednesday, November 6, snapping a five-day winning streak. The decline was largely driven by the strengthening US dollar, as early reports suggested that Republican candidate Donald Trump was gaining ground in the race for a second term as president.

The stronger US dollar places downward pressure on oil and other commodities, making them more expensive for buyers using other currencies. **Brent crude oil futures** fell to **\$73.64 per barrel**, marking a drop of 2.5% from the previous close of **\$75.53**, while **WTI crude futures** dropped to **\$70.22**, down 2.45% from the prior close of **\$71.99**.

Crude prices have been volatile in recent days, influenced by a mix of factors, including OPEC+'s decision to delay its December production plan for the second time, rising geopolitical tensions in the Middle East, and expectations surrounding the upcoming **US Federal Reserve policy meeting**. Additionally, signs of economic recovery in **China**, the world's largest crude importer, have been affecting market sentiment.

Volatile Crude Oil Market

Rahul Kalantri, VP of Commodities at Mehta Equities, commented on the volatility, noting that crude oil prices rebounded last week, driven by a

drop in US oil stocks and heightened geopolitical unrest. **US crude oil inventories** fell by 0.5 million barrels, which was contrary to expectations of a 1.5-million-barrel increase. This was a significant shift from the previous week, when inventories had risen by 5.5 million barrels.

"Geopolitical tensions in the Middle East and the possibility of OPEC+ delaying production increases supported the recovery in crude prices. However, the strengthening US dollar and weak economic data from Europe tempered the gains," Kalantri added.

Dollar Index Reaches Four-Month High

The **US Dollar Index** surged by 1.9% to **105.30**, marking its highest level in nearly four months. This increase came amid growing expectations of a Trump victory in the **2024 US presidential election**. The dollar's strength was further fueled by Trump's improving position in several key swing states, particularly **Pennsylvania**, which Trump won, putting him just three electoral votes shy of securing the White House.

As the election results unfold, analysts expect oil prices to remain volatile, driven by fluctuations in the dollar and ongoing geopolitical developments.





WhatsApp's New 'Search on Web' Feature Aims to Tackle Fake Images

WhatsApp, the popular messaging platform owned by Meta, has long been a go-to app for staying connected with friends, family, and colleagues. However, it has also become a breeding ground for misinformation, especially in the form of fake images and messages. While WhatsApp has implemented various measures to tackle this issue, the growing use of AI-generated fake images has once again raised concerns about the authenticity of visual content shared on the platform.

lenge, WhatsApp is reportedly working on a new feature that will make it easier for users to verify the authenticity of images without having to leave the app. This new functionality, called 'Search on Web,' is designed to help users quickly perform a reverse image search using Google Lens, which can determine whether an image has been altered or is circulating on the internet.

process eliminates the need to manually open a browser, go to Google Lens, and upload the image for verification, making it much quicker and more convenient for users to check the credibility of an image before forwarding it.

Currently, the 'Search on Web' feature is available only to a limited group of testers in the WhatsApp beta program. This means it may take some time before it is rolled out to the broader user base. However, once it becomes widely available, this feature is expected to be a valuable tool in the fight against misinformation and fake news on the platform, helping users make more informed decisions about the content they receive and share.

Rare 1,000-Year-Old Gold Coin Featuring Jesus Christ Discovered in Norway

The more carbon dioxide you emit, the more likely you are to be bitten by mosquitoes

Many people have been told that mosquito bites are caused by "sweeter" blood, but recent research suggests there might be a more scientific explanation: carbon dioxide (CO2) emissions. Mosquitoes are primarily attracted to CO2, which humans and animals exhale during respiration. This discovery sheds light on why some individuals seem to be more prone to mosquito bites than others.

Dr. Jinendra Jain, a consultant physician at Wockhardt Hospital, Mira Road, explains that it's not the sweetness of the blood that attracts mosquitoes but the levels of CO2 in the air. "Mosquitoes are drawn to higher concentrations of carbon dioxide, which is commonly exhaled by humans and animals," Dr. Jain says. Increased CO2 levels, especially in areas with warmer temperatures and climate change, create an ideal environment for mosquito breeding.



Dr. Mallika Motta, MD (Homeopathy) at The Vital Dose Homeopathy Clinic, adds that mosquitoes have nerve cell receptors that can detect carbon dioxide from over 30 feet away. "This is one of the primary ways mosquitoes locate their hosts," she explains. The more CO2 a person exhales, the more likely they are to attract mosquitoes. This explains why larger groups of people, who emit more carbon dioxide, are often more susceptible to mosquito bites.

Furthermore, human activities that increase CO2 emissions, such as burning fossil fuels, could contribute to higher concentrations of CO2 in the atmosphere, making it a more attractive environment for mosquitoes.

Apart from CO2, mosquitoes are also attracted to certain compounds found in human sweat and on the skin. Lactic acid, ammonia, and other body chemicals can make a person more appealing to these pests.

In conclusion, while factors like body odor and sweat do play a role, carbon dioxide emissions—both natural and human-induced—are a key factor in why mosquitoes target certain individuals more frequently. Reducing CO2 emissions could not only benefit the environment but may also help lower the frequency of mosquito bites in certain areas.






