Following the incident, senior police officers launched an investigation to determine the source of these threats and whether Pawan Kalyan or other ministers' offices had been targeted in a similar manner. Authorities are also examining the timing and details of when these calls and messages were received. The incident has raised concerns within the government, as it marks an unusual escalation in threats directed at the Deputy CM.

## **483 Metric Tons of Ration Rice** Seized at Visakhapatnam Port

- ₹12,000 Crore Worth of PDS Rice Exported Illegally in 3 Years
- **Crackdown on Ration Mafia Intensifies**

#### **TPN CORRESPONDEDNT** Visakhapatnam, DEC-10

State Food and Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar has vowed to take decisive action against the illegal transportation of Public Distribution System (PDS) rice. Speaking to the media after a surprise inspection at Visakhapatnam Port on Monday, he revealed large-scale smuggling operations involving ration rice meant for the poor.

During the inspection, 483 metric tons of PDS rice, prepared for export, were seized at the port's container freight station. Minister Manohar stated that intensified surveillance at Kakinada Port had prompted smugglers to shift operations to Visakhapatnam over the past two months. He assured the public that a comprehensive investigation is underway and stern action will follow. ₹12,000 Crore Smuggling Operation Exposed

Manohar disclosed that during the previous administration, 1.38 crore metric tons of PDS rice, valued at approximately ₹12,000 crore, were smuggled



from Kakinada Port, with another 36,000 metric tons exported from Visakhapatnam over three years. Recent inspections at Visakhapatnam Port uncovered that 70,000 metric tons of ration rice were transported in just two months.

Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu has established a Special Investigation Team (SIT) through the CID to investigate and curb the smuggling operations. Minister Manohar confirmed that a detailed report on the illegal activities at Visakhapatnam Port will be submitted to the SIT.

The minister emphasized that state and central authorities are collaborating to tackle

these crimes, pledging a "zero tolerance" approach. He added that the misuse of PDS rice affects the 1.48 crore ration cardholders it is meant to serve, while the diversion benefits smugglers earning profits under the guise of exporting rice as part of the "Quality of Rice Project of India."

Manohar urged the public and media to support the government in its efforts to eradicate the ration rice mafia. He stressed that ensuring the security of the country and the rights of the poor should be a collective responsibility. He also warned traders against attempting to smuggle ration rice, announcing that severe penalties will be imposed.

### **Nagababu Likely to Join AP Cabinet**

Speculations are rife about actor and Jana Sena leader Nagababu being inducted into the Andhra Pradesh Cabinet. As the political landscape evolves, sources indicate that Nagababu, brother of AP Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, may soon take oath as a minister, representing Jana Sena in the state cabinet.

Earlier, it was rumored that Nagababu would be appointed as the TTD Chairman, a position eventually taken by BR Naidu. Later, discussions shifted to Nagababu possibly being nominated to the Rajya Sabha as three seats from Andhra

Pradesh became vacant. However, with two seats going to the TDP (Beda Mastana Rao and Sana Satish) and one to the BJP (R. Krishnaiah), the Rajya Sabha opportunity for Nagababu did not materialize. Now, the focus has shifted to state politics. Sources suggest that Pawan Kalyan prefers Nagababu to remain active in state politics to strengthen Jana Sena at the grassroots level, rather than moving to a national role in Delhi. Nagababu played a key role in the recent elections, leading his brother's campaign in Pithapuram constituency and boosting party morale across Andhra Pradesh.

Given Pawan Kalyan's respon-

sibilities as Deputy Chief Minister, having Nagababu in the cabinet would not only bring him closer to the party ranks but also strengthen Jana Sena's presence within the alliance with the TDP and BJP. An official announcement on Nagababu's induction into the cabinet is expected soon, marking another significant step in the TDP-Jana Sena alliance's governance strategy. Meanwhile, TDP Rajya Sabha candidates from Andhra Pradesh have been finalized. Beda Mastana Rao and Sana Satish have been confirmed by the TDP high command, while the BJP has already announced R. Krishnaiah as its Rajya Sabha candidate.





# Toll Tax on Roads in 16 AP Cities

The Andhra Pradesh government is set to introduce toll taxes on state roads, aligning them with national highways. A comprehensive plan is being finalized to develop and maintain roads across 16 cities under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model. This initiative will allow contractors to recover costs through toll collection and advertising revenue.

The project encompasses the development of 642.90 km of roads within urban local bod-

ies, including corporations, municipalities, and city panchayats. Contractors will be tasked with constructing and maintaining these roads for ten years, with responsibility for any required remains during the period

for any required repairs during the period. Visakhapatnam accounts for the highest road coverage under the plan, with 253.05 km slated for development. Other cities include Nellore (83 km), Guntur (60 km), Kakinada (39 km), Vizianagaram (33 km), Chittoor (29 km), Kadapa (28 km), Anantapur (21 km), Tirupati (19 km), Vijayawada (17 km), Srikakulam (12 km), Machilipatnam (11 km), Kurnool and Rajahmundry (7 km each), and

Eluru (5 km).

The government will soon approve the prepared plan, after which tenders will be invited for execution. Contractors who secure these tenders will commence construction and simultaneously ensure road maintenance for the next decade.

Apart from toll collection, contractors will also have the opportunity to generate revenue through advertisements along the developed roads. This initiative is expected to significantly improve road infrastructure, ensuring better connectivity and travel convenience for citizens across Andhra Pradesh.

#### AP Government Launches Survey to Identify Bogus Pension Beneficiaries TPN Correspondent

Amaravati, Dec 9

In a significant move to curb fraudulent pension claims, the Andhra Pradesh government has launched a survey to identify ineligible beneficiaries before granting new pensions. This decision comes as the state continues to receive complaints regarding pension distribution, with many individuals reportedly receiving pensions despite not meeting eligibility criteria.

Currently, the state has around 65 lakh pension beneficiaries, with more than three lakh applications for new pensions pending. The government has decided to conduct a pilot survey in select secretariats across the state to verify the authenticity of existing pension claims. The two-day survey (on December 9 and 10) will be carried out by four teams, each working in a secretariat chosen from each district.

The survey will assess the validity of pension claims through a set of 13 questions designed to identify those who are eligible for pensions and those who are not. To ensure unbiased results, the government has directed that staff from neighboring mandals be appointed for the inspections, rather than local Secretariat staff, to prevent any potential conflicts of interest.

The collected data will be entered into an app, and a photo of each pensioner will be taken as part of the verification process. Based on the feedback from the pilot project, the government plans to extend the survey across 15,004 village and ward secretariats statewide.

The initiative aims to identify ineligible beneficiaries and streamline the pension distribution process, ensuring that only deserving individuals receive financial support. Following the completion of the survey, the government is expected to make a decision on the disbursement of new pensions.

### YS Avinash Reddy's PA Appears Before Kadapa Cyber Crime Police

YCP MP YS Avinash Reddy's personal assistant Raghav Reddy appeared before the Kadapa Cyber Crime Police today for questioning in connection with inappropriate social media posts targeting Sharmila, Vijayamma, and Sunitha.

The investigation stems from the earlier interrogation of Varra Ravindra Reddy, who reportedly claimed that the controversial posts were not made by him but originated from Avinash Reddy's office. He alleged that the content was provided by Raghav Reddy, leading to a case being registered against the latter a month ago.

While police had been searching for Raghav Reddy, he obtained a stay on arrest from the High Court until December 12. Upon arriving in Pulivendula, Raghav Reddy was issued notices to attend questioning at the Kadapa Cyber Crime Office.

The police clarified that the investigation aims to gather details and does not include an arrest at this stage. Further developments are awaited.

# AP on High Alert as Heavy Rains Continue; Warning Issued for Several Districts

Heavy rains continue to lash Andhra Pradesh, with the state on high alert as a series of low-pressure areas persist over the region. For nearly 15 consecutive days, several districts in AP have been experiencing continuous rainfall, and the situation is expected to persist at least until December 15, as per the latest warning from the Meteorological Department.

The low-pressure system, formed in the southeast Bay of Bengal, remains active and is expected to strengthen further over the next 24 hours. This system is moving towards the west-northwest, bringing widespread rains to areas including Rayalaseema and the southern coastal districts. Meteorologists predict that rain will continue in various parts of the state, with moderate to heavy showers expected for the coming week.

The AP government has issued urgent instructions to district administrations in response to the ongoing weather conditions. Key measures include the immediate transfer of harvested paddy to rice mills to prevent damage, and ensuring that paddy stocks in granaries remain dry to avoid spoilage.

The Meteorological Department has also issued warnings of severe waves

along the coasts of Srikakulam, Krishna, and Nellore for the next four days, adding further concern for coastal communities. Additionally, forecasts suggest that another low-pressure area may develop near the Andamans around December 14 or 15, which could bring additional heavy rainfall to Andhra Pradesh by mid-December. Given the prolonged nature of these rains, the state government is closely monitoring the situation and advising the public, especially farmers and coastal residents, to remain vigilant. The ongoing weather pattern suggests that the rains are unlikely to subside soon, even as the winter season approaches.

### **Botsa Expresses Gratitude to Chandrababu and Pawan TPN CORRESPONDENT**

The political landscape in Andhra Pradesh is heating up as the coalition government completes six months in power, with the YSRCP government increasing pressure to fulfill election promises. Opposition leader Botsa Satyanarayana made significant comments during the recent Legislative Council session, thanking Chandrababu Naidu and Pawan Kalyan for reminding the public of the development achieved during their rule, particularly through the Nadu-Nedu program.

Botsa appreciated the recent parents-teachers meeting organized by the AP government, which highlighted the improvements made in schools under the previous government's tenure. However, he suggested that it would have been more appropriate for Chandrababu and Pawan Kalyan to commit to completing the remaining work in schools through Nadu-Nedu. He also demanded an immediate reduction in the increased charges that were imposed during the coalition government's time.

Botsa addressed the controversial issue of the container ship allegedly carrying drugs that arrived in Visakhapatnam, clarifying that investigations under Operation Garuda, including a check by Interpol, found no drugs on board. He expressed plans to write to the Prime Minister and Home Minister about the CBI's handling of the case.

Further criticizing the current government's performance, Botsa accused it of failing to support



farmers and vowed to meet with district collectors to submit a petition in support of the farming community. He also announced plans to protest against increased electricity charges, submitting a petition to SEs by the end of the month.

YSRCP is planning a state-wide program on January 3 to demand the release of fee reimbursement. Additionally, he revealed that he had written to MLCs urging them to participate in an assembly committee related to the Visakhapatnam dairy case, reiterating his call for their inclusion in the committee's activities.

## **3-Time BRS MLA Found Not** Indian, Fined Rs 30 Lakhs

**TPN Correspondent** Hyderabad, Dec 9: In a shocking turn of events, the Telangana High Court has fined former BRS MLA Chennamaneni Ramesh Rs 30 lakh for deceiving the electoral system regarding his Indian citizenship. The case has sent shockwaves through the political landscape as Ramesh, who served as the Vemulawada MLA for three consecutive terms, was found to be a German citizen, not an Indian as he had claimed.

The issue first came to light when Ramesh's competitor, Adi Srinivasa, filed a long-standing legal battle, arguing that Ramesh was contesting the election with false documentation. The case had been under litigation for several years, with Srinivasa challenging the authenticity of Ramesh's Indian citizenship.

In a landmark ruling today, the Telangana High Court declared that Chennamaneni Ramesh had falsely represented himself as an Indian citizen during his electoral campaigns. As a result, the court imposed a fine of Rs 30 lakh on Ramesh, which includes Rs 25 lakh in compensation to Adi Srinivasa for contesting



the elections with fake documents, and Rs 5 lakh to the Legal Services Authority for its role in the case.

Ramesh, who was elected MLA from the BRS party for three terms, had created fraudulent documents to claim Indian citizenship. However, the court's verdict confirmed that he was, in fact, a German national, a violation of election laws that prohibit foreign citizens from contesting Indian elections. This unprecedented case has raised serious questions about the integrity of the electoral process and the checks and balances in place to verify candidates' eligibility.





## **Conditional Bail Granted to Kukkala** Vidyasagar in Jethwani Case

**TPN CORRESPONDENT** Vijayawada, DEC-10 YSRCP leader Kukkala Vidyasagar, the main accused in the high-profile Jethwani case, has been granted conditional bail by the Andhra Pradesh High Court. The case, which involved allegations of harassment against Mumbai actress Kadambari Jethwani, has drawn significant attention in the state. The bail petition was

fiercely contested, with advocate Narra Srinivas and Public Prosecutor Lakshmi Narayana arguing on behalf of the complainant and the police, opposing the bail on grounds that it could impact the case. Senior advocate Niranjan Reddy represented Vidyasagar, emphasizing that the accused had already spent 76 days in custody. After hearing arguments from both sides, the court reserved its judgment before granting bail on Monday.

Vidyasagar was apprehended by Vijayawada police in Dehradun, Uttarakhand, after evading authorities for weeks. Following his arrest, he was brought to Vijayawada on a transit warrant after being produced before the Third Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate in Dehradun.

The police investigation revealed that Vidyasagar had moved between Mumbai and Delhi before being caught. The case also implicated three senior IPS officers—PSR Anjaneyulu, Kantirana Tata, and Vishal Gunni—who were



suspended for alleged misuse of power and involvement in the case.

Kadambari Jethwani filed multiple complaints, including one against Vidyasagar and several police officers, accusing them of filing false cases and subjecting her to mental harassment. The Ibrahimpatnam police registered a case under various sections, naming Vidyasagar as the primary accused.

A comprehensive investigation led by ACP Sravanthirai of the NTR Police Commissionerate involved statements from Kadambari, her parents, and other witnesses. A detailed 100page report was submitted to the government. In response to the allegations, Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu approved the suspension of three senior IPS officers, along with two lower-ranking officers, Ibrahimpatnam CI Satyanarayana and ACP Hanumantha Rao. Orders under G.O. Nos. 1590, 1591, and 1592 were issued, with the details marked confidential on the government website.

## New Railway Line in AP: Vijayawada to Secunderabad in Just 3.40 Hours

Railway infrastructure in Andhra Pradesh is receiving a significant boost under the NDA government's third term at the center. With the central government accelerating pending projects in the state and providing necessary funding, key initiatives are progressing at a rapid pace.

One of the pivotal projects is the Nallapadu-Bibinagar doubling and electrification, spanning 248 kilometers at an estimated cost of ₹2,853 crore. The entire expense is being borne by the central

government, with work bedivided ing phases into and assigned to contractors to ensure

#### timely completion. **Project Phases**

- Phase 1: 47 km between Nadikudi and Kukkadam at a cost of ₹571 crore.
- Phase 2: 56 km between Nallapadu and Bella-• mkonda with a budget of ₹600 crore.
- Phase 3: 75 km between Kukkadam and Veligonda estimated at ₹700 crore.

The total cost of these three phases is ₹1,871 crore, and work is underway simultaneously. Notifica-

tions for land acquisition in Andhra Pradesh have been issued, while similar steps are awaited in Telangana.

#### **Enhanced Connectivity**

Once the double line is operational, travel from Guntur to Secunderabad will take just three hours, while the Vijayawada-Secunderabad journey will be reduced to 3.40 hours. This new line will also



provide an alternative route from Secunderabad to Chennai and Tirupati, connecting Guntur to the Chennai route via Tenali.

### Manchu Manoj Files Police Complaint..

**TPN Correspondent** Hyderabad, Dec 10: Actor Manchu Manoj has filed a complaint with the Pahadi Sharif police station in Hyderabad, alleging that ten unidenindividuals tified attempted to attack him at his residence. The incident reportedly occurred vesterday morning while Manoj was at home with his wife and children.

According to the complaint, the attackers fled when Manoj tried to apprehend them. In the process, Manoj sustained in-

juries and later sought medical treatment at a private hospital in Hyderabad. Reports of a possible altercation within the Manchu family surfaced after his hospitalization, but the family has denied these claims.

The Pahadi Sharif police inspector provided details, stating, "Manchu Manoj reported that the attackers came to his home and tried to harm him. He mentioned being assaulted while trying to catch them. However, he has not named any family members, including Mohan Babu, in his complaint."

Manoj also alleged that the CCTV footage capturing the incident was destroyed. He specifically mentioned the involvement of two individuals, Vijay Reddy and Kiran, in tampering with the evidence. The police have assured that this aspect will be



thoroughly investigated.

The inspector revealed that a Dial 100 call was received about the incident. When officers arrived at Manoj's residence, only Manoj, his wife, and children were present. Manoj claimed that the attack occurred around 9 a.m. the previous day.

The police have registered a case and initiated an investigation into the incident. They are looking into the alleged disappearance of the CCTV footage and the motives behind the attack. Manoj stated in his complaint that he is unaware of the reason for the assault but expressed concerns for his family's safety.

This incident has sparked significant attention, with further developments anticipated as the investigation continues.

# Bhutan's Royal Visit to India: Strengthening Ties Amidst Regional Challenges



On December 6, 2024, Bhutan's King Jigme Khesar Namgyal Wangchuk and Queen Jetsun Pema concluded a two-day visit to India, where they met with Prime Minister Narendra Modi and External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar. This visit was a reaffirmation of the strong bilateral relations between the two nations, underscoring the mutual trust and cooperation that define their ties.

During the visit, India reiterated its commitment to supporting Bhutan's development and growth. The Ministry of External Affairs highlighted the "spirit of mutual trust, cooperation, and profound understanding" that forms the foundation of the relationship between the two countries. The discussions covered various issues of shared interest, including clean energy and hydropower development. India also expressed its support for the Gelephu Mindfulness City, a significant project spearheaded by Bhutan's king, reflecting India's continued encouragement of Bhutan's socio-economic progress.

Although India and Bhutan share close ties, Bhutan's evolving relationship with China has introduced new complexities in the region. Bhutan and China have yet to establish full diplomatic relations, but in recent years, there have been steps toward resolving their border disputes. In October 2023, Bhutan and China signed

cating their border, signaling a potential shift in Bhutan's diplomatic direction. Bhutan's government has expressed its belief that resolving the boundary issue with China would serve the long-term interests of the country.

Despite these developments, there are concerns about China's growing influence along the disputed border. Reports indicate that China has been constructing villages in contested areas, with these settlements expanding in both size and number, further complicating the territorial dispute. These actions have raised tensions and are seen as a way for Beijing to exert pressure on Bhutan in its border negotiations.

In terms of defense, Bhutan relies heavily on India for military support. The Bhutanese army is small and often depends on India for training and assistance. This was evident during the 2017 Doklam crisis, when Indian forces intervened to protect Bhutan's sovereignty and prevent China from constructing a road through disputed territory. This resulted in a tense 73-day standoff between Indian and Chinese forces.

As Bhutan navigates its diplomatic challenges with China, its relationship with India remains a cornerstone of its security and development. The visit underscored the enduring strength of India-Bhutan ties, which continue

## Why An Unstable Middle East Is A Risk For India



Over the past decade, India has transformed its "Link West" policy into a robust "Act West" strategy, shifting from transactional partnerships to a comprehensive, strategic relationship with Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries. These oil-rich nations are also pursuing their own "Act East" policies, aligning their ambitions with India's vision for a "Viksit Bharat" by 2047. This growing synergy has been evident through high-level exchanges, with Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi visiting several GCC nations, including the UAE, which is India's third-largest trading partner.

India's relations with the GCC have expanded beyond bilateral ties, with multilateral initiatives such as the I2U2 (India, USA, UAE, Israel), IUSU (India, UAE, Saudi Arabia, USA), and India-GCC partnerships taking center stage. These collaborations cover a range of sectors, including trade, investment, energy, and defense, while also addressing broader regional issues. However, the ongoing instability in the Middle East, particularly the 14-month war in Gaza and escalating tensions in Syria and Lebanon, threatens to undermine these initiatives. These conflicts raise concerns about energy and food security, economic engagements, and the safety of millions of Indian expatriates in the region.

To address these challenges, India has become more active in multilateral and regional frameworks, including participation in the G20, COP mechanisms, and organizations like BRICS and the SCO, where several Middle Eastern countries are involved. India's growing engagement is not limited to the GCC but extends to other countries in the region, such as Qatar, Bahrain, Kuwait, and Egypt.

In recent weeks, India's External Affairs Minister, S. Jaishankar, has undertaken significant diplomatic missions, including visits to Qatar, Bahrain, and Oman. These meetings have focused on strengthening bilateral relations and addressing regional security concerns, particularly the volatile situation in the Middle East. Jaishankar's visit to Qatar coincided with the Doha Forum, where key discussions were held on the Israel-Hamas ceasefire and the ongoing conflict in Syria.

India's strategic commitment to the region is evident through its active role in maintaining maritime security and ensuring the safety of merchant shipping routes. As regional tensions continue to rise, India's emphasis on regional stability and pragmatic diplomacy remains critical to maintaining peace and security in an increasingly unstable environment.

### The Fall of Syria: A Catalyst for Regional Instability and Extremist Resurgence

The ongoing upheaval in Syria is on the brink of reshaping the Middle East's power dynamics, with consequences far beyond its borders. One of the key figures in this shift is Muhammad al-Jawlani, once labeled a terrorist by the U.S., now emerging as a leader with growing political legitimacy. This transformation, facilitated with Western support, highlights the risks of meddling in a region where alliances can shift unpredictably. The critical question remains: will the fall of Bashar al-Assad's regime lead to the resurgence of Daesh (ISIS) and increase threats to Israel?

The fragmentation of Syria can be traced to its historical roots. After the collapse of the Ottoman Empire, colonial powers drew Syria's borders in the Sykes-Picot Agreement, disregarding the region's complex ethnic and sectarian makeup. When Syria gained independence in 1946, it inherited a fractured society marked by tensions

between Sunnis, Alawites, Kurds, and Christians. The Assad family's rise to power in 1971 cemented an authoritarian regime that relied heavily on the Alawite minority, sowing resentment among the Sunni majority. The Arab Spring protests in 2011 ignited these tensions, with Assad's brutal crackdown escalating into a full-blown civil war.

As the conflict unfolded, various Islamist groups, including al-Jawlani's Al-Nusra Front, took advantage of the power vacuum. Syria became a battleground for proxy wars, with international and regional powers fueling the chaos. The current push to remove Assad may seem like a step towards democracy, but the void left behind raises grave concerns. In removing a brutal but stable regime, Western powers have created fertile ground for extremist factions to regain strength, with al-Jawlani's Hay'at Tahrir al-Sham (HTS) now emerging as a major player.

The potential resurrection of Daesh looms large in the wake of Assad's downfall. Historical precedents from Iraq and Libya show how the collapse of autocratic re-



gimes can lead to the rise of extremist groups. With Syria's fractured state, these groups, including remnants of Daesh, have the opportunity to thrive once again, creating a direct threat to regional stability and Israel's security.

For Israel, the rise of groups like HTS, which openly opposes the Jewish state, is a nightmare scenario. The collapse of Syria's government creates a volatile environment at Israel's borders, where radical factions could unite and pose an even greater threat. Hezbollah in Lebanon, another staunch enemy of Israel, could further destabilize the region, creating the potential for a two-front conflict.

The fall of Syria is a double-edged sword, with the danger of unleashing a new wave of extremism. The U.S. and its allies, in their quest for regime change, may have inadvertently set the stage for a more dangerous and unstable Middle East. As the region teeters on the brink, the ramifications of this power shift will continue to unfold, with dire consequences for the future of Syria and its neighbors.

#### **Speedy Justice in Indian Courts**

In India, where over 51 million cases remain pending across all levels of the judiciary, the call for judicial reform has never been more urgent. Thus, a balance must be struck between technological assistance and the essential human element in the justice system.

The Supreme Court's initiative, such as the "Supreme Court Portal for Assistance in Courts Efficiency" (SUPACE AI), represents a positive step toward incorporating AI specifically tailored for the Indian judicial system. SUPACE, designed to assist judges by collecting relevant facts, is an example of how AI can be utilized to support judicial functions without overstepping its role.

In conclusion, AI has the potential to be a vital ally in the pursuit of speedy and accessible justice in India.

#### **Farmers pleading for justice** because Modi govt 'betrayed' them again and again: Kharge

Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Monday criticized the Modi government for betraying farmers repeatedly and called for justice for the agricultural community. Addressing the ongoing struggles faced by farmers, Kharge highlighted the numerous unfulfilled promises by the government, including the failure to meet their income goals and implement critical agricultural reforms.

Kharge raised pointed questions to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, asking why farmers have to repeatedly come to Delhi seeking justice. He urged Modi, who was scheduled to visit Haryana and Rajasthan, to understand the plight of farmers who are essential in feeding the nation.



"Farmers are pleading for justice because your government has betrayed them again and again," Kharge remarked. He listed several unfulfilled promises that have left farmers frustrated, such as the government's failure to double their income by 2022, as well as the non-implementation of the Swaminathan Commission's recommendation to guarantee a Minimum Support Price (MSP) of Input Cost + 50%. Kharge further criticized the formation of a committee to provide legal status to MSP, saying the government has failed to take any meaningful action to address the issue. These unkept promises, according to Kharge, have contributed to the ongoing agrarian distress.

#### Will we have lollipop while you occupy our land: Mamata to **Bangladeshi politicos**

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday addressed provocative comments made by some Bangladeshi politicians, who claimed that Bangladesh had legitimate territorial rights over Bengal, Bihar, and Odisha. Speaking in the West Bengal Assembly, Banerjee dismissed such statements and urged residents of the state to remain calm and composed in the face of external provocations.

Banerjee mocked the remarks of certain Bangladeshi leaders and stressed that such statements should not disturb

the peace of West Bengal. "Stay calm and healthy and have peace of mind," she advised. The comments from Bangladesh's Nationalist Party (BNP) leader, who made the territorial claim during a recent public meeting in Dhaka, had raised concerns among many in India.



In her speech, Banerjee emphasized unity, saying that the state's people, regardless of religion or community, have

condemned the situation in Bangladesh, particularly the attacks on minorities. "The same blood flows in the veins of Hindus, Muslims, and all other communities. We must work together to prevent aggravating the situation in West Bengal," she said, highlighting the importance of solidarity across religious lines.

Banerjee also acknowledged the collective protests by people in West Bengal against the situation in Bangladesh, and urged her political rivals and media outlets to be responsible in their commentary on the issue. She advised against inflaming tensions, stating, "If trouble breaks out here, it will affect us all. Similarly, if the situation worsens in Bangladesh, it will affect our relatives and friends there."

The Chief Minister reiterated her government's stance of following the Ministry of External Affairs' guidelines on foreign matters. She called for patience, emphasizing that her party, the Trinamool Congress, would refrain from speaking out of turn until the outcome of diplomatic discussions between India and Bangladesh were clear.

The resolution, which was introduced by Water Resources Minister Duraimurugan, was passed unanimously by the Assembly. Interestingly, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), despite its usual opposition, chose not to oppose the resolution at the introductory stage.

The issue of tungsten mining in Tamil Nadu has sparked significant controversy, with local communities raising concerns about the environmental consequences of such projects. The government's swift response highlights the growing tensions between development projects and environmental protection in the state.





# Will Make It "Easier" For People To Come in Legally To US: Trump

WASHINGTON: Incoming US President Donald Trump reiterated his stance on immigration, vowing to deport all illegal immigrants once he takes office. He emphasized that his administration would strictly enforce immigration laws, starting with removing criminal offenders.

Trump outlined his plan to focus first on deporting individuals involved in criminal activities, particularly gang members like MS-13 and violent offenders, such as murderers and those released from mental institutions. He criticized the release of violent criminals, saying, "We had 13,000 murderers released into our country over the last three years. They're walking down the streets. They're very dangerous."

While he remains firm on deporting illegal immigrants, Trump also expressed his intention to make legal immigration easier for those wishing to enter the country. He suggested that prospective immigrants would need to pass a simple test, demonstrating knowledge about American history and a love for the country. He added, "They have to be able to tell you what the Statue of Liberty is," referring to the type of civic knowledge immigrants would be expected to have.

Addressing the issue of undocumented



individuals brought to the US as children, commonly referred to as "dreamers," Trump stated that the situation would be tackled in the future. While he acknowledged their contributions to American society, he also mentioned the need to work with Democrats on finding a solution for this group. Trump highlighted that the Dreamers, many of whom are now middle-aged, have established lives in the US and said that "Republicans are very open"



### War Can't Be Finished: Zelensky On Trump's Call For Immediate Ceasefire

KYIV: Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky has firmly rejected US President-elect Donald Trump's call for an immediate ceasefire between Russian and Ukrainian forces, emphasizing that Kyiv will not accept any peace agreement without strong security guarantees. Trump, in a recent interview, suggested that his administration might reduce aid to Ukraine and advocated for a ceasefire and peace talks. However, Zelensky stated that the ongoing war cannot be resolved by "just a piece of paper and a few signatures" and stressed the need for lasting, reliable peace.

Zelensky made his comments after meeting Trump in Paris on Saturday, alongside French President Emmanuel Macron. While Trump has expressed his ability to swiftly end the conflict, he did not provide specifics on how he would achieve that. He also reiterated his favorable relationship with Russian President Vladimir Putin.

In response, Zelensky conveyed Ukraine's need for an "enduring" peace that would protect the nation from future Russian aggression. Although he had previously opposed territorial concessions, Zelensky has recently softened his stance, suggesting that Ukraine might temporarily forgo control of certain Russian-occupied territories in exchange for NATO security guarantees and continued Western military support. Zelensky emphasized that peace must be long-lasting and credible, warning that the war should not drag on endlessly. The Ukrainian leader also acknowledged the heavy toll of the war, revealing that 43,000 Ukrainian soldiers had been killed, and over 370,000 wounded. He underscored that Ukraine's desire for peace is stronger than anyone else's, but Russia's actions have continuously disrupted that peace. Zelensky called on Western allies not to ignore the ongoing occupation by Russia and reiterated that any peace agreement must guarantee Ukraine's security.

Meanwhile, Russia has accused Ukraine of refusing to negotiate, with Kremlin spokesperson Dmitry Peskov stating that Ukraine's conditions for talks are unacceptable, as they do not include ceding control of four disputed regions.

#### **Biden Calls Collapse of Assad's Regime a "Historic Opportunity"** for Syria's Future

#### **Rebel Leader Abu Declares Victory,** Signals End of Assad's Rule and Iranian Influence in Syria

MOSQUE: Abu Mohammad al-Jolani, the leader of the Islamist group Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS), has declared a "historic" victory in Syria, marking a significant turning point in the country's long-running conflict. Speaking from the Umayyad Mosque in Damascus on December 8, 2024, Jolani, who led a successful offensive that took control of the Syrian capital in less than two weeks, announced the end of Bashar al-Assad's regime. Jolani, who previously led al-Qaeda's Syrian branch before distancing himself from the group, now heads Syria's largest rebel faction and has positioned himself as a key figure in shaping the country's future.



In his speech, Jolani emphasized Syria's "purification," signaling that the country's regional reputation as a narco-state was about to end. He specifically highlighted how Assad's Syria had become the world's leading source of Captagon, an amphetamine-type drug, and how criminality had spread throughout the region under Assad's rule. Jolani's comments appear to be directed not only at the Assad regime but also at regional powers whose support he will need moving forward.

Jolani, who now uses his given name, Ahmad al-Sharaa, instead of his nom de guerre, also referenced the waning influence of Iran in Syria, further solidifying his break from past alliances and signaling his readiness to lead a post-Assad Syria free from foreign intervention. His remarks suggest a new phase for Syria, one where the country's leadership may shift away from the entrenched Assad regime and Iranian influence, opening a potential path for a more pluralistic and tolerant future, as Jolani has expressed interest in embracing religious diversity.

As the head of HTS, Jolani now finds himself at the forefront of the post-Assad political landscape, with the potential to become a key figure in Syria's reconstruction. His victory in Damascus, along with his rejection of past extremism, has elevated his status, while the future of Syria hangs in the balance.

#### India Raises Concerns Over **Minority Attacks in Bangladesh**

Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri, during his visit to Dhaka, expressed India's concerns over recent attacks on religious minorities in Bangladesh. In a meeting with Bangladeshi Foreign Adviser Mohammad Touhid Hossain, Misri condemned the attacks on religious institutions, describing them as "regrettable."

Misri highlighted India's desire for a "positive, constructive, and mutually beneficial" relationship with Bangladesh, despite the tense diplomatic atmosphere. He emphasized that India's primary concern is the safety and welfare of minorities in Bangladesh, especially following the surge in violence against the Hindu community.

Misri further discussed the troubling incidents of violence, which have included vandalism and desecration of religious places. He called for addressing these issues with sensitivity, expressing regret over the targeted attacks on cultural and religious properties.

The meeting, which was described as "frank, candid, and

constructive," provided both sides an opportunity to assess their bilateral ties. Misri's visit marks the first high-level meeting between India and Bangladesh since the political upheaval in Bangladesh following the ousting of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in August.

Bilateral relations between the two countries have been strained due to several issues, including rising violence against religious minorities in Bangladesh. Tensions escalated after Hasina fled to India following a massive anti-government protest. Subsequently, the interim government under Nobel laureate Mohammad Yunus has faced criticism for its handling of the violence, with reports of mob attacks targeting Hindus and Hindu priests being prosecuted.

WASHINGTON: Outgoing US President Joe Biden hailed the collapse of Bashar al-Assad's regime as a "historic opportunity" for the Syrian people, marking the end of decades of authoritarian rule and over 13 years of devastating civil war. His comments came shortly after Syrian rebel forces successfully seized control of the country, forcing Assad to resign and reportedly flee to Moscow.

Biden, in his statement, emphasized the significance of this moment for the Syrian population, who have endured immense suffering under

Assad's rule. He described the regime's fall as an unprecedented opportunity for the Syrian people to rebuild their nation, free from the decades of oppression and violence that defined the Assad government. "This is a chance for Syria to turn a new page, one where the voices of the people can be heard and where they can shape a future based on freedom and justice," Biden said.

# **Indices End with Moderate Losses Amid Mixed Market Signals**

The domestic stock market indices closed **I** with moderate losses on Monday, following a day of fluctuations influenced by mixed signals from global and Asian markets. After opening flat, the indices traded within a narrow range until the afternoon, and European markets reached their lows after opening, as they continue to remain in a consolidation phase. The Sensex and Nifty both recorded losses, with FMCG, media, and consumption shares facing the brunt of the

The BSE Sensex, which had closed at 81,709 in the previous session, opened at 81,602 on Monday. It touched an intraday low of 81,411 and a high of 81,783 before finally closing at 81,508, down by 200 points. The NSE Nifty opened at 24,633, reached a

Wipro, LT, SBI Life, Tata Steel, and BPCL were the top gainers, while Tata Consumers, Hindustan Unilever, Tata Motors, Nestle India, and Asian Paints were the biggest losers. Sector indices for tourism, defense, metal, consumer durables, IT, and PSE saw marginal gains, while FMCG, media, consumption, auto, oil and gas, pharma, PSU bank, and energy sectors experienced losses.

Market breadth on the NSE was slightly positive, with 1,546 stocks advancing and 1,318 declining out of 2,944 shares traded. A total of 140 companies reached 52-week highs, while 13 stocks touched 52-week lows.

The Indian rupee weakened by 4 paise, closing at 84.73 against the dollar. # **Indian Consumer Confidence Weakens Amid Rising Inflation, Says RBI**

According to the latest survey by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Indian consumers' confidence in the country's general economic situation, employment prospects, and their own income and spending has weakened. The survey revealed a noticeable decline in consumer sentiment, reflecting growing concerns about economic conditions and financial stability.

The RBI's findings indicate that house-





The State Bank of India (SBI) has projected that India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) will grow at 6.3% during the ongoing fiscal year (FY25), revising down its earlier estimates. This projection is lower than the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) revised estimate of 6.6%, which was adjusted from a previous forecast of 7.2%.

SBI's projection comes after India's GDP growth slowed to 5.4% in the July-September quarter of FY25, marking the lowest growth rate in seven quarters. This slowdown raised concerns over the overall pace of the economy, with analysts pointing out that the first quarter of FY25 had already shown weaker-than-expected performance.

SBI explained that its forecast was influenced by a range of factors, including weak domestic consumption, global headwinds, and slower growth in industrial production. The bank also noted that this was not an unusual situation, referencing similar downward revisions in previous fiscal years. In FY22 and FY23, GDP growth projections were also downgraded by about 90 basis

points on average, reflecting broader economic challenges.

While the RBI had recently revised its GDP growth estimate for FY25, Governor Shaktikanta Das acknowledged the slowdown but expressed confidence that the economic conditions would improve in the coming quarters. However, even with the downward revisions, both the RBI and SBI remain optimistic about the long-term growth trajectory of the Indian economy.

Meanwhile, SBI also commented on the RBI's recent decision to cut the Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) by 50 basis points (bps) to 4%. While this move is expected to infuse ₹1.16 lakh crore into the banking system, SBI anticipates only a modest positive impact of 3-4 bps on banks' net interest margins. The CRR reduction will occur in two phases, with cuts scheduled for December 14 and December 28.

With the budget approaching, the focus now shifts to fiscal policies that could address the challenges posed by slower growth and inflationary pressures.



He formed a vital 99run partnership for the fourth wicket with captain Shai Hope, who made 86 off 88 balls. Rutherford's knock brought the team closer to their target before he was dismissed by off-spinner Mehidy Hasan Miraz, caught by Jaker Ali at midwicket.

Rutherford then joined forces with Justin Greaves (41 not out) in a crucial 95-run partnership for the sixth wicket, which put the West Indies within reach of victory. Despite his early

exit, Rutherford's remarkable performance was enough to take West Indies to the brink of success. He was named the Player of the Match for his efforts.

Captain Shai Hope praised Rutherford's consistency and improvement in his batting. "We ask for consistency, and he's showing that," said Hope. "He strikes the ball really well, and the hard work is paying off. He was disappointed not to finish the game, but he played a pivotal role in the win."

Earlier in the day, Bangladesh, after winning the toss and opting to bat, made a strong start. Opener Tanzid Hasan contributed 60 runs, while captain Mehidy Hasan Miraz scored 74. A partnership of 96 between Mahmudullah (50 not out) and Jaker Ali (48) pushed Bangladesh to a total of 294/6, but it wasn't enough to deny the West Indies, who chased down the target with Rutherford's heroics.

# India Drawn in Tough Group for **2027 Asian Cup Qualifiers**


