

# IS JATWANI'S CASE SOLD TO JINDAL?



Jatwani Kadambari, Mumbai Actress who is a victim of Vijayawada Police is still waiting for the arrests of IPS officials. On 31st August 2024, Jatwani Kadambari has filed her complaint against the Vijaywada Police and Kukkala Vidyasagar. Liquor business is also in the grip of MLA as per locals. They are saying that all the liquor shop holders have to pay monthly commission to MLA and few shops are running by MLA's associates only. They are giving targets to the shops on sales so that their share will be increased.

Whatever the business, they have to pay the commission prescribed the MLA batch allegedly. Based on the category of the business, they will decide the percentage. Even for the new comers, MLA batch inviting for discussions to settle the deal allegedly.

Surprisingly registrations also rendering income to MLA allegedly. Any registration the share of MLA should be paid as per the locals. Like this, MLA Prathipati Pulla Rao set a target of Rs.5 Crores every month for his associates allegedly. They have a clear-cut work division, who has to take care of which business and who has to collect in sand sales, who has to collect in liquor sales like that. As a Minister, Mr. Prathipati has gained lot of experience in the collection and now he found new ways and escalated his collection in a big way, a local has commented.

# If you are helpless, where should the average person go?

#### Dy CM Pawan Kalyan Expresses Discontent at Collectors' Conference

Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan made sharp comments on governance issues during a collectors' conference held in Andhra Pradesh today. Expressing dissatisfaction over the functioning of the administration, he criticized the helplessness of collectors in addressing pressing issues such as the rampant sand mafia and other irregularities.

Pawan Kalyan questioned the role of collectors, asking, "If you are helpless, where should the average person go?" He pointed out that systemic failures and political interference have eroded governance, leaving common citizens vulnerable.

Highlighting the unchecked sand mafia, the Deputy CM alleged that interference by MLAs had hindered attempts to regularize sand mining. Despite Minister Nadendla Manohar's efforts to curb adulteration and irregularities, Pawan noted that tangible results were yet to be seen.

Pawan warned MLAs against further interference in the sand business, asserting that strict action would be taken. He urged collectors to act in accordance with the rule book, stating, "We are here to do good for the people and will provide you with the necessary support. What is stopping you from strengthening the system?"

Referring to the previous government's role, Pawan alleged that the revenue machinery, under political influence, engaged in various irregularities from selling movie tickets to illegal sand mining. He expressed disappointment that senior IAS officers failed to challenge such practices, despite their stature and responsibilities.

Pawan cited the consequences of public discontent in countries like Sri Lanka and Syria as a warning, emphasizing that inefficient governance could lead to mass revolts. He stressed the importance of a responsive administration, urging officials to prioritize public welfare and adhere to democratic values.

Pawan lauded former Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu for his vision in transforming Hyderabad into a global city. He credited Naidu for envisioning Cyberabad amidst rubble, driving economic and infrastructural growth.

"When we travel on the flyovers in Hyderabad, we see the vision of Chandrababu. He is a tireless worker who took the state forward," Pawan remarked.

Andhra Pradesh, Dec - 12

The Andhra Pradesh High Court has expressed serious concerns over the rising number of deaths due to non-use of helmets, with over 660 fatalities reported in the past three months. The court criticized the police for failing to enforce traffic rules effectively and questioned their role in reducing these preventable deaths.

In a hearing prompted by a petition from High Court lawyer Tandava Yogesh, the court highlighted the alarming statistics and expressed its frustration with the lack of strict action against violators. The bench emphasized that if traffic rules, including mandatory helmet use, were enforced rigorously, many of these fatalities could have been avoided.

In response, the High Court instructed the police to strictly implement helmet laws and enforce traffic violations more aggressive-

sential services like water and electricity to homes of those who fail to pay traffic fines. Additionally, it reminded authorities that vehicles of non-compliant individuals could be seized under existing legal provisions.

The court also raised concerns over the vacant positions in the traffic police department and questioned why steps had not been taken to address the shortage. The High Court pointed out that traffic rules are being followed more diligently in Hyderabad, where even minor infractions like seatbelt use and black film on windows are strictly controlled. The court noted the contrast in enforcement between the state capital and other regions of Andhra Pradesh.

The bench ordered that the Traffic IG and the Transport Commissioner appear before the court at the next hearing, scheduled for December 18, 2024. This comes after several previous directives from the court to ensure helmet usage among two-wheeler riders.



**AP 10th Class and Intermediate Exam Schedules Released** by Education Minister Nara Lokesh

Andhra Pradesh Education Minister Nara Lokesh has officially released the schedule for the upcoming 10th class and intermediate exams for the year 2024.

The 10th class exams will commence on March 17, 2024, while the intermediate exams will begin on March 1, 2024. The intermediate exams will be held between March 1 to 31, with the first-year exams scheduled from March 1 to 19, and the second-year exams from March 3 to 20.

Key exam dates for intermediate students include the Ethics and Human Values exam on February 1, and the Environmental Education exam on February 3, both from 10 am to 1 pm.

Practical exams for second-year MPC and BPC students will take place from February 10 to 20, while practical exams for inter vocational courses will be held from February 5 to 20.

In a message to students, Nara Lokesh urged them to focus on their preparation and remain calm. "Dear students, the time has come to focus on the exams. Prepare in a planned manner, and don't let stress affect you. Take care of your health and perform to the best of your abilities," he said.

For 10th class students, Lokesh reassured them, "We are conducting the exams on alternate days to give you ample time to prepare. Use this extra time wisely to study and excel in your exams. I wish all the very best to my 10th class brothers and sisters."

fostered by progressive policies, has attracted both domestic and international investors. This, he said, is paving the way for increased employment opportunities across the state.



#### **Farmer Welfare**

In a scathing tweet, Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar criticized the previous government's handling of farmer welfare, specifically targeting Former Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy. Manohar, in his tweet, highlighted the stark contrast in grain procurement under the two administrations. The minister pointed out that during the current government's tenure, a total of 15.40 lakh metric tons of grain had been collected, compared to just 8.23 lakh metric tons under Jagan's rule. ### **Severe Low Pressure Causes Sudden Weather Change in South Coastal Districts of AP**

A case has been registered against Jayasudha, wife of YSRCP leader and former minister Perni Nani, in connection with a ration rice scam. The Machilipatnam police took action following a complaint from Civil Supplies Department officer Kotireddy.

The controversy dates back to the previous government when Perni Nani allegedly con-

structed warehouse in his wife Jayasudha's name. This warehouse was later rented out to the Civil Supplies Department for storing Public Distribution System (PDS) rice stocks.

Recently, officials conducted an inspection of the warehouse and discovered a significant discrepancy in the inventory. They reported that 185 tons of PDS rice were missing from the stocks. The Civil Supplies Department raised concerns about the mismanagement and irregularities, leading to a formal complaint against Jayasudha.



### Four Arrested for Stealing from Passengers, ₹1.5 Lakh Seized

The Vijayawada City Police have arrested four individuals involved in robbing passengers by stealing from them at crowded locations such as bus stands. The police seized Rs. 1.5 lakh from the accused.

On the evening of December 11, the CCS team, with the help of Krishna Lanka Police, apprehended four individuals near Padmavati Ghat, located near the Pandit Nehru Bus Stand. The arrested suspects have been identified as Burri Suresh (47) of Visakhapatnam, Aritakula Tarakeswara Rao (44), Kambala Srinu (42) of Kailasapuram, and Budumuri Raju (35) of Kobbarithota. All of them are long-time friends with several previous theft-related offenses.



During interrogation, the suspects revealed that they targeted crowded areas such as bus stands, where they would discreetly steal money or valuables from unsuspecting victims. The thieves would distract their targets while one of them picked their pockets, with the others blending into the crowd.

One such incident took place on December 6, 2024, when they stole money from a complainant's pocket at the bus stand while he was accompanying his brother-in-law to the hospital. The victim later filed a complaint at the Krishna Lanka Police Station, which led to the investigation and subsequent arrest. The police have recovered Rs. 1.5 lakh

from the suspects, who have been taken into custody for further legal proceedings.


3. Sriram Konthamuru (absconder). These individuals, along with two other associates, were involved in stealing motorcycles from various locations by

### **The Fall of Damascus: A Reflection on History** and Power



Damascus, one of the oldest cities in the world, has once again fallen. Its cyclical nature of power shifts, violent regime changes, and ethnic and religious clashes throughout history provide valuable lessons for modern societies. While the city has witnessed regime changes from the Roman conquest in the 1st century AD to the most recent developments, the ongoing contestation for socio-political dominance has shaped its character. Today, the fall of Damascus underlines how the cycles of power and its socio-political dynamics continue to influence the region.

In July 2012, rebels breached Damascus, a city long considered inviolable, signaling the start of a long and bloody conflict. While the Syrian regime responded with overwhelming force, including Operation Capital Shield in 2013, to defend the capital, it was only a temporary measure. Eleven years later, the regime fell yet again. Throughout history, Damascus has witnessed similar power shifts, not only due to military conquest but also through ethnic and religious clashes such as the Crusades.

Damascus holds immense historical significance as a thriving trade hub along the Silk Roads, as highlighted in Peter Frankopan's \*The Silk Roads\*. Though it lacked direct access to the Mediterranean, it competed with cosmopolitan cities like Constantinople, Antioch, and Chang'an. The fertile land of Damascus, bolstered by irrigation infrastructure from the Barada River, allowed the city to prosper agriculturally. Even during the height of religious conflicts in the 10th century AD, Damascus maintained its status as a trading epicenter, where Muslim and Christian traders coexisted peacefully, protected by the city's political tolerance.

Interestingly, Damascus was never ruled by a local dynasty, a feature that aligns it more closely with cities like Delhi than with its Phoenician or Arab neighbors. Its history is marked by the dominance of "outsiders" who integrated into the local culture, helping shape its growth. This characteristic mirrors that of Delhi, offering insights into the political evolution of cities that have seen multiple waves of foreign influence.

The current developments in Syria and the fall of the Assad regime offer critical lessons in liberalism's limitations. The Assad family's politicization of Syria's multicultural society fueled resentment, particularly among the Sunni majority, marginalized by the Alawite (Shia) regime. The Syrian civil war, driven by both political and socio-religious factors, is a reminder of the dangers of exclusionary politics. The rise of conservative forces, often in reaction to liberal elitism, has caused upheaval across the globe, as seen in Afghanistan, Iran, Turkey, and Bangladesh. The fall of Damascus has sparked celebrations and looting, but the political aftermath is not one of simple victory. Israel has already moved to assert control, planting its flag beyond the previous buffer zone. This historical perspective should serve as a cautionary tale for regimes and rebels, particularly in Delhi, to understand the complex interplay of power and the cyclical nature of conflict in shaping the future of cities and nations.

The revitalization of Kashi, Ayodhya, and Prayagraj reflects India's broader cultural renaissance, driven by pride in the nation's heritage and supported by government initiatives. These efforts are not only preserving India's cultural fabric but also creating new economic opportunities, setting a powerful example of blending tradition with progress.

### India's Economic Struggles: Denial, **Desperation, and Policy Shifts**

Five years ago, policymakers in New Delhi were largely in denial about the deep economic stagnation gripping the country. Despite signs that wage incomes were stagnating to such an extent that Indians were cutting back even on inexpensive items like 7-cent cookies, little action was taken. Fast forward to today, and while there has been some progress, much of the core issues remain unaddressed.

One of the more alarming indicators of ongoing financial stress is the sharp rise in loans against gold. With a staggering annual growth rate of over 50 percent, these loans signal that lower-income borrowers are being forced to pledge their gold—often their most prized possession—as collateral in order to survive. This is a clear sign of desperation among India's working class, struggling to stay afloat amid mounting financial pressures.

While there was a temporary rebound following the pandemic, driven by pent-up demand, a boom in stock-market wealth, and an expansion in household credit, the recovery now appears to have run its course. The excitement is fading, and India finds itself returning to the same economic stagnation it faced before the pandemic. Despite the challenges, the government's economic czars remain largely silent about the slowdown. They point to the busy election season and its impact on public spending, but their public statements fail to address



the deeper structural issues at play.

Privately, however, it seems the government is starting to acknowledge the gravity of the situation. To signal a change in economic direction, India's finance ministry has decided to make a key personnel shift. Sanjay Malhotra, a senior official in the ministry, is set to replace Reserve Bank of India Governor Shaktikanta Das. This change could pave the way for a much-needed rate cut, as experts believe that the current restrictive monetary policy, partially responsible for the economic slowdown in recent months, may need to be loosened. With meaningful private investment and job creation still lacking, India is at a crossroads. The shift in leadership may signal a shift in economic strategy, but whether it will be enough to address the underlying issues or whether it will only delay the inevitable remains to be seen. India's leaders will need to confront these challenges head-on if the country is to break out of its economic rut and return to sustainable growth.

# The AI Czar Debate: Visionary or Catastrophic for India?

The recent announcement by the United States about appointing an "AI Czar" has stirred up discussions about whether India should follow suit. While the concept seems to promise a strategic move for the future, it could also create significant challenges. Appointing an "AI Boss" in India could lead to a "highly combustible conundrum," combining progress with potential chaos.

On one hand, having an AI Czar would signal India's commitment to leading in the digital age. But on the other, it invites the possibility of political and corporate interference. Who would fill such a position? Perhaps a retired political figure seeking a cushy post-retirement role? Or a tech mogul with ties to industries eager to profit from AI policies? The appointment of such a figure could inadvertently breed conflicts of interest and impede unbiased policymaking.

AI is not just another technological advancement; it is a transformative force that will shape the future of society, economy, and even the way we go about our daily lives. The United States, by appointing an AI Czar, is aiming to assert its global leadership in the digital age. On the contrary, India seems more focused on hosting conferences and entertaining visits from international tech giants like NVIDIA and OpenAI. However, this focus raises the ques-



tion: Are we positioning ourselves as consumers rather than creators in the AI revolution?

Indeed, while India is a large consumer market and offers cheap labor, the intellectual property and profits from AI technologies still rest predominantly in the West. India's role as a consumer of global innovation is undeniable, but to truly lead in AI, we must shift our focus from merely adopting Western innovations to developing our own.

If India is to become a leader in AI, a unifying figure is essential—someone capable of coordinating efforts across ministries, states, and industries. However, this individual must possess patience, political acumen, and diplomatic finesse to navigate complex challenges. They must balance the interests of policymakers, industry leaders, and even the judiciary. But the stakes are high: mishandling this role could result in regulatory capture, stalled innovation, or fragmented policies.





# Vladimir Putin to Visit India for 23rd **Annual Bilateral Summit with PM**

**CM Stalin Inaugurates Renovated** Periyar Memorial in Kerala for Vaikom Satyagraha Centenary

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin arrived in Kerala to inaugurate the renovated Thanthai Periyar Memorial and Granthasala in Vaikom, Kottayam, alongside Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan. This event, scheduled for December 12, coincides with the centenary of the Vaikom Satyagraha, a historic movement that fought for social justice and caste equality.

On social media, Stalin reflected on the significance of the Vaikom Satyagraha, stating, "How was our society a hundred years ago and imagine where we have reached now! I will participate in the hundred years completion of Vaikom protest which seeded these changes."

The Vaikom Satyagraha, a key non-violent movement between 1924 and 1925 in Travancore, challenged caste-based discrimination that prevented lower-caste people from using roads surrounding the Vaikom Sree Mahadeva Temple. This movement, led by figures such as TK Madhavan, K Kelappan, and Periyar EV Ramasamy, became a significant moment in Kerala's modern history and a test for Gandhian non-violent resistance. Though partial success came in 1925, when three of the four roads were opened to the oppressed, full equality was achieved only in 1936 with the Temple Entry Proclamation.

Periyar, known as the "Vaikom Veerar" (Hero of Vaikom), played a crucial role in the Satyagraha, advocating for complete equality. The renovated Periyar Memorial, funded by Tamil Nadu at a cost of Rs 8.5 crore, stands as a tribute to his legacy. The complex, spread over 70 cents of land, includes a photo exhibition hall, library, children's park, visitor's pavilion, and a statue of Periyar in a seated posture. In addition to the Vaikom memorial, Tamil Nadu is building another memorial at Arookutty in Alappuzha, where Periyar was jailed during the Satyagraha. Kerala has recently transferred land for this project, announced by Stalin in 2023.



# **"Protect Minorities In Violence-Hit Bangladesh": Mamata Banerjee To Centre**

### **Changes In Cost Of Fuel**, **Road Can Bring Logistics Cost To 9%: Nitin Gadkari**

Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari, addressed the Rising Rajasthan Global Investment Summit 2024 in Jaipur on Tuesday, emphasizing that reducing fuel and road costs could lower India's logistics cost by 9%. "Compelled To Take Step, **Chairman Biggest Disruptor** In Rajya Sabha": M Kharge

Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge on Wednesday explained why the opposition was forced to table a no-confidence motion against Rajya Sabha Chairman Jagdeep Dhankhar, calling him the "biggest disruptor" of the Upper House. Kharge accused Dhankhar of undermining the dignity of the institution and claimed that the opposition had no choice but to take this step after facing repeated obstruction.

Kharge emphasized that the motion was not a "personal fight" against Dhankhar but a reaction to his actions that, according to him, hurt the functioning of the Rajya Sabha. "We are compelled to take this step. For three years, he gave us neither time nor space to raise critical issues," Kharge said, stressing that the opposition had been denied opportunities to voice concerns on important matters.

The Congress chief also criticized Dhankhar for showing favoritism toward the ruling party. "We expect protection from the Chairperson, but he keeps gesturing to ruling party MPs to speak. Who will listen to the opposition when the Chair himself defends the government?" Kharge said. He added that the Chairman's behavior was reminiscent of a "headmaster" scolding MPs, accusing him of working as the government's spokesperson.

The no-confidence motion, which the opposition filed earlier in the day, was based on accusations of partisan behavior by Dhankhar. This development triggered a heated exchange in Parliament, with BJP MPs fiercely defending the Rajya Sabha Chairman. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju rejected the motion, asserting that the NDA had the majority in the Rajya Sabha and that the notice would be rejected. Rijiju also came to Dhankhar's defense, calling him "our guide" and accusing Congress of repeatedly insulting the Chair. The face-off between Congress and BJP MPs had intensified over a claim of alleged collusion between Congress leader Sonia Gandhi and businessman George Soros, which led to further tensions between the two sides.

#### "No possibility of alliance with **Congress for Delhi polls**"

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) supremo Arvind Kejriwal on Wednesday firmly rejected any possibility of an alliance with the Congress for the upcoming Delhi Assembly elections, scheduled for February. The former Delhi Chief Minister reiterated that there would be no coalition with the Congress, dismissing speculation surrounding a potential partnership.

His statement came in response to media reports suggesting that the AAP and Congress might form a joint front to contest the 70-member Delhi Assembly. The speculation gained traction following the cancellation of a key Congress event, the "Nyay Chaupal," which was supposed to be the culmination of the party's "Nyay Yatra" across Delhi ahead of the elections. Rahul Gandhi, Congress leader and MP, was expected to participate in the event, which fueled rumors of a possible alliance between the two parties.

Despite the buzz around a potential Congress-AAP tie-up, Kejriwal remained steadfast in his stance. "There is no possibility of any alliance with the Congress," he asserted, further dashing hopes of a united front between the two parties.

In a separate development, Kejriwal also met Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) chief Sharad Pawar on Tuesday. This meeting took place amid rising calls within the opposition Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance (I.N.D.I.A) to appoint West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee as the head of the political grouping, currently led by Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge. The rejection of any alliance with the Congress highlights AAP's independent stance as the Delhi Assembly elections approach, with the party focusing on its own agenda rather than partnering with the opposition. As the election draws closer, the dynamics within I.N.D.I.A and the fate of potential alliances in other regions remain subjects of political intrigue.







# **Bangladesh Court Denies Bail for** Hindu Priest Chinmoy Krishna Das

DHAKA: A Bangladesh court has rejected the bail plea of Chinmoy Krishna Das, a Hindu priest and spokesperson for the Bangladesh Sammilit Sanatan Jagran Jote, who has been arrested on charges of sedition. The court's decision, delivered by Chittagong Metropolitan Sessions Judge Md. Saiful Islam on Wednesday, cited the absence of a lawyer's letter of attorney, which is required for such hearings.

Das, a monk affiliated with the International Society for Krishna Consciousness (ISKCON), has been arrested in connection with a case that his defenders argue is false and fabricated. His lawyer, Subhashish Sharma, was unable to attend the hearing on December 3 due to security concerns. The petition for bail will now be heard again on January 2, 2025.

Public Prosecutor Mofizul Haque Bhuiyan confirmed that the state party informed the court that lawyer Rabindra Ghosh, who had applied for Das's antic-



ipatory bail hearing, did not have the necessary power of attorney. This procedural issue led to the rejection of the bail application. The court also noted that the bail hearings of two other accused individuals could not take place for similar reasons.

Das, who suffers from various health issues, including diabetes and respiratory problems, has been detained for over a month. His arrest follows a pattern of rising concerns over the treatment of minorities in Bangladesh, particularly Hindus. The arrest coincides with increasing attacks on religious and cultural minorities by extremist groups in the country.

India has expressed concerns about the situation, urging the Bangladesh government to ensure a "fair and transparent" trial for the arrested individuals, including respect for their legal rights. The Indian Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) has also called on the Bangladeshi authorities to provide adequate protection for minorities and ensure their rights to peaceful assembly and expression.

India's Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri reiterated these concerns during his visit to Dhaka on December 9, where he met with top Bangladeshi officials, emphasizing the need for a constructive approach to safeguard religious and cultural freedoms.

### **Donald Trump Economic Plan** Will Be Disaster: Joe Biden



WASHINGTON: Outgoing US President Joe Biden on Tuesday criticized Donald Trump's economic proposals, calling them a "disaster" and warning of their potential harm to the US economy. In a speech at the Brookings Institution, Biden specifically challenged Trump's threat to impose heavy tariffs on imports, labeling them a "major mistake." He also urged Trump to build upon the successes of his own administration.

Biden's remarks came after Trump secured a second term largely fueled by voter frustration with rising living costs under Democratic leadership. Biden, who is preparing to leave office in January, warned that Trump's economic agenda, including the proposed tariffs on key trading partners like Mexico, Canada, and China, would significantly raise prices for US consumers. "I believe this approach is a major mistake," he added.

At another event, Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen echoed Biden's concerns, stating that Trump's tariff plans could "derail the progress we've made on inflation and growth." Yellen cautioned that sweeping tariffs would increase costs for consumers and pressure companies dependent on imports. Biden's speech was framed as a major defense of his economic legacy, especially as he prepares to leave office. At 82, Biden decided not to seek re-election in 2024, passing the torch to Vice President Kamala Harris, who was defeated by Trump in November. Despite this, Biden remains active in defending his policies and contrasting his "middle-out, bottom-up economic playbook" with Trump's "trickle-down economics."

Biden highlighted the US economy's recovery post-Covid and his administration's significant investments in green technology and industry. He also praised the economic conditions that Trump will inherit, claiming that Trump is stepping into the "strongest economy in modern history."

# South Korean Police Block Raid on President **Yoon's Office Amid Martial Law Investigation**

SEOUL: South Korean police announced on Wednesday that security guards had blocked an attempt to raid President Yoon Suk Yeol's offices as part of an investigation into his brief imposition of martial law. Yoon is already facing restrictions, including a travel ban, as part of a broader investigation into his inner circle's involvement in the controversial events of December 3-4.

Police earlier stated that a Special Investigation Team had initiated raids on various government agencies, including the presidential office and the National Assembly Security Service. However, a spokesperson later clarified that investigators were able to access the office's civil services division but were unable to enter the main building due to security restrictions imposed by the president's guards.

# **Netanyahu Rejects Corruption Charges as Historic Trial Continues**

TEL AVIV: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu dismissed the corruption charges against him as "ridiculous" during a historic court appearance on Tuesday. Netanyahu, facing bribery, fraud, and breach of public trust charges in three separate cases, became the first sitting Israeli prime minister to stand trial. The cases date back to his time in office while Israel is engaged in military conflicts.

Speaking before the court, Netanyahu rejected the accusations, stating, "There's no corruption, no fraud. It is just ridiculous." He also criticized the media, claiming that while most of the Israeli public leans right-wing, the media is "98 percent on the other side." Throughout the day of testimony, Netanyahu maintained his stance, saying the charges did not affect him, and emphasized that his focus was on matters man James Packer.

The charges include allegations that Netanyahu and his wife, Sara, accepted over \$260,000 worth of luxury gifts such as cigars, champagne, and jewelry from billionaires in exchange for political favors. Among the accused benefactors are Israeli-born Hollywood producer Arnon Milchan and Australian businessThe trial also includes two cases involving Netanyahu's attempts to secure favorable media coverage. One concerns alleged negotiations with Arnon Mozes, publisher of \*Yedioth Ahronoth\*, for positive press in return for curbing the influence of a rival newspaper. The second case accuses Netanyahu of using his influence to benefit Shaul Elovitch, owner of the Walla news website, in exchange for favorable coverage and support for a telecom merger.

Protests have surrounded the trial, with supporters chanting "Netanyahu, the people support you," while critics called for his imprisonment. The trial has faced delays, with Netanyahu requesting adjournments due to ongoing conflicts in Gaza and Lebanon. Critics argue that the prime minister has prolonged the conflicts to avoid justice.

transitional Prime Minister, Mohammad al-Bashir, assumes leadership following the fall of President Bashar al-Assad. The Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS)-led rebels, who ousted Assad three days ago, appointed al-Bashir to oversee the country's transition until March 1. In his first interview, al-Bashir called for "stability and calm," emphasizing the need for the people to enjoy peace after years of conflict.

However, amid this political shift, Israel has intensified its military operations in Syria. The Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) carried out over 350 airstrikes in the past 48 hours, targeting weapons stockpiles and critical infrastructure. These strikes hit several strategic sites, including Syrian Navy facilities at Al-Bayda and Latakia ports, airfields, missile depots, tanks, fighter jets, and anti-aircraft batteries. Israeli Defense Minister Israel Katz confirmed the destruction of the Syrian navy fleet and reported Israeli troops setting up positions at the buffer zone near the Israeli-occupied Golan Heights.

Turkey also carried out aerial strikes in Syria, destroying a convoy of trucks carrying missiles and heavy weapons that had reportedly been seized by Syrian Kurdish militias. These operations reflect the broader regional involvement in Syria's conflict.

In the diplomatic sphere, US Secretary of State Antony Blinken emphasized the importance of an inclusive political process in Syria, stating that the US would support a future government that is credible, inclusive, and non-sectarian. He called for external interference to cease, with the Syrian people determining their government's future.

HTS commander Ahmed al-Sharaa, also known as Abu Mohammed al-Jolani, reassured the world that Syria was moving toward stability and development. He downplayed fears of further conflict, noting that the regime's removal was crucial for peace. Meanwhile, the United Nations is considering whether to remove HTS from its terrorist list, based on the group's actions and its potential to form an inclusive government.

# Syria Appoints Interim Prime Minister as Refugees Begin Returning



DAMASCUS: As Syria's long-standing civil war winds down, refugees are beginning to return to the country, following the appointment of a new caretaker prime minister. Mohammed al-Bashir, a figure largely unknown outside rebel circles, was appointed by the rebel faction Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS) to lead a transitional government until March 1. In his brief address on state television, Bashir confirmed his leadership and noted that the interim cabinet had included members from both the rebel

Salvation Government and the ousted Assad regime.

The US, while engaging with the rebel groups, has urged them to establish an inclusive government that respects minority rights and prevents terrorism. US Secretary of State Antony Blinken emphasized the need for a government that can facilitate humanitarian aid and maintain stability, particularly with Syria's neighbors. The challenge ahead for Syria is immense, as the country

faces the monumental task of rebuilding after a civil war that left hundreds of thousands dead and millions displaced. Major cities are in ruins, and the economy is severely damaged by international sanctions. Despite this, some refugees, particularly those from Turkey, have started their journey home. Ala Jabeer, who fled Syria 13 years ago, is among them. He expressed hope for a better future in Syria, especially after witnessing the end of Assad's oppressive regime.

In Damascus, signs of recovery were visible, with businesses reopening, banks resuming operations, and normal activity returning to the streets. However, the country remains deeply divided, and the international community remains cautious about the rebel-led government.

The US has expressed concerns over the HTS's history, with some officials skeptical about the group's ability to respect minority rights and religious freedom.



# SEBI Expands T+0 Settlement Cycle for Top 500 Scrips Starting January 2025

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) announced on Tuesday that it will expand the optional T+0 (same-day) settlement cycle for equity cash markets, effective January 2025. Under this initiative, the top 500 scrips by market capitalization, as of December 31, 2024, will be included in the T+0 settlement cycle, which aims to enhance market efficiency and offer more flexibility to participants.



Participation in this window is optional, with trades executed here settled on the same day.



The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has revised India's GDP growth forecast for the current financial year, lowering it to 6.5% from its earlier projection of 7%. The downgrade comes due to weaker-than-expected growth in private investment and housing demand. In addition, ADB has also adjusted India's growth forecast for the 2025-26 financial year, now predicting a growth of 7%, down from its previous estimate of 7.2%.

The ADB's latest report on the economic outlook also highlighted a slowdown in growth across the Asia-Pacific region, with overall growth for 2024 expected to be 4.9%, slightly lower than the earlier forecast of 5%. The report also noted that changes in U.S. trade, fiscal, and immigration policies could impact growth and inflation in developing economies in Asia and the Pacific.

India's economic performance has been subdued in recent quarters. In the July-September period of FY25, India's GDP grew at just 5.4%, marking a seven-quarter low. This figure was well below the Reserve Bank of India's fore-

cast of 7%. Last week, the RBI also revised its GDP growth estimate for the current fiscal year, lowering it to 6.6% from 7.2%, while increasing the inflation forecast to 4.8%, citing a slowdown in economic activity and persistent food price inflation.

Despite these challenges, ADB remains optimistic about India's medium-term growth prospects, supported by a strong agriculture output, particularly from the summer crop season, and a resilient services sector. Additionally, lower-than-expected global crude oil prices are expected to provide further economic relief.

ADB's report also suggested that there are signs of recovery in India's economy, with strong forward-looking indicators such as industrial and services PMI, urban labor force participation, and the Reserve Bank of India's industrial outlook.

In contrast, Southeast Asia's growth outlook has been raised to 4.7% for this year, driven by stronger manufacturing exports and public capital spending.

in March 2024, where the T+0 cycle was introduced for 25 scrips, initially limited to non-custodian clients. With the inclusion of the top 500 scrips, the expansion will occur in phases. Starting in January 2025, the bottom 100 companies from the list will be added to the T+0 settlement cycle, followed by the next 100 companies each month until all 500 scrips are covered. This expansion will complement ments from 8:45 AM to 9:00 AM daily.

This move builds on SEBI's earlier rollout the existing 25 scrips already under the T+0 cycle.

> SEBI has also allowed all stock brokers to participate in the T+0 settlement cycle, enabling them to charge differential brokerage fees for T+0 and T+1 settlements, as long as the fees remain within regulatory limits. Additionally, a separate block deal window will operate for T+0 settle-

Qualified Stock Brokers (QSBs) with a minimum number of active clients by December 31, 2024, will be required to implement systems for seamless participation in T+0 settlements. Newly designated QSBs will have three months to comply with these requirements after updates to the QSB list. SEBI has also directed stock exchanges, clearing corporations, depositories, and custodians to develop infrastructure for enabling institutional investors to participate in T+0 settlements.

The expanded provisions for scrips, broker participation, and operational guidelines will take effect on January 31, 2025. However, requirements for QSBs, custodians, and block deal windows will be implemented by May 31, 2025.

However, for 32-year-old Australian woman Rachel Olivia, what seemed like a simple pimple on her forehead turned into a life-changing discovery. After a small red breakout failed to heal, Rachel learned that it was actually skin cancer.

According to the \*New York Post\*, Rachel initially dismissed the pimple as a minor skin problem. However, when it continued to flake and showed no signs of healing over time, she decided to seek medical advice. A biopsy confirmed that the condition was not a simple pimple but basal cell carcinoma (BCC), a form of skin cancer. "I left it for a year, but when it never healed, I pushed to get it reassessed by specialists," Rachel explained to \*news.com. au\*. "They did a biopsy and confirmed it was cancer."

Rachel, who considered herself "sun-smart" among her friends and family, had always been caua few severe sunburns during her teenage years, a factor that contributed to her skin cancer diagnosis. "I've never been someone to tan or sit in the sun. But I did have a few bad burns when I was younger, and that's all it takes," Rachel shared.

Basal cell carcinoma, the type of skin cancer Rachel was diagnosed with, is often caused by sun damage. It affects the basal cells in the skin's epidermis, the top layer of skin. While BCC is typically less aggressive than other forms of skin cancer, early detection is crucial for effective treatment and prevention of further complications.

Rachel's experience serves as a reminder of the importance of monitoring any skin changes, even those that seem harmless, and seeking medical advice when necessary. Her journey highlights how sunburns, even in the past, can have long-term consequences on skin health.

# **Japan's 1-Day Student Programme Offers Tourists A Glimpse Of Local School Life**

# **Ultra-Processed Foods Accelerate Biological Aging, Study Warns**

I f you're some-one who loves bingeing on ultra-processed foods (UPFs) like chips, biscuits, sausages, burgers, soft drinks, and instant noodles, it's time to reconsider your choices. A recent study from Monash University in Australia revealed has that a diet high in UPFs can accelerate biological aging.

Biological age,

a relatively new health measurement, re- Dr. Barbara Cardoso, a senior lecturer in fers to how old a person seems based on the University's Department of Nutrition, molecular biomarkers, rather than their chronological age. A person with a healthy lifestyle can have a biological age younger than their chronological age, while poor lifestyle habits, including a diet rich in UPFs, can cause biological age to increase faster.

The study, published in the journal \*Age and Aging\*, involved 16,055 participants from the US, aged 20-79. The results showed that for every 10% increase in UPF consumption, biological age increased by the highest quintile of UPF consumption (68-100% of their energy intake) were biologically 0.86 years older than those in the lowest quintile (who consumed 39% or less of their energy from UPFs).



Dietetics, and Food, emphasized the importance of minimizing UPF consumption, suggesting that eating more unprocessed and minimally processed foods can significantly benefit long-term health. "Our findings are significant, showing that a 10% increase in energy intake from ultra-processed foods correlates with nearly a 2% higher risk of mortality and a 0.5% higher risk of chronic disease over two years," Dr. Cardoso added.

UPFs are industrial formulations conapproximately 2.4 months. Participants in taining ingredients rarely used in home cooking, such as hydrogenated oils, high-fructose corn syrup, and various flavor enhancers and emulsifiers. These foods tend to be high in unhealthy salts, sugars, and fats, offering convenience but at a cost to long-term health.





# **Shaheen Afridi Becomes Pakistan's First Bowler to Take 100 Wickets in Each Format**

Afridi then trapped Ngabayomzi Peter in front of the stumps, claiming his 100th T20I wicket and finishing with impressive figures of 3/22 from his four overs.

Despite Afridi's heroics, Pakistan fell short in the chase. Facing a challenging target of 184, Pakistan's captain Mohammad Rizwan top-scored with 74, but a lack of support from the other end saw them lose by 11 runs, failing to cross the finish line.

# **West Indies Beat Bangladesh** By 7 Wickets In 2nd ODI

**B**randon King and Jayden Seales were the standout performers as the West Indies secured a series-clinching seven-wicket victory over Bangladesh in the second ODI on Tuesday. With Bangladesh bowled out for 227, the West Indies comfortably chased down the target with 79 balls to spare, following their five-wicket win in the first ODI on Sunday.

King played a stellar knock, scoring 82 runs from 76 balls, including eight fours and three sixes. It was his seventh half-century in ODIs, adding to his three centuries. His innings was a perfect early birthday gift, as he turns 30 next Mon-

day. King's opening partnership with Evin Lewis but Seales' fourth wicket, that of Mahmudullah, (49 off 62 balls) laid a solid foundation, with the duo putting on 109 for the first wicket.

After King's dismissal, Keacy Carty continued the momentum, contributing 45 runs before falling. West Indies captain Shai Hope (17) and Sherfane Rutherford (24) then guided the team to victory, with Rutherford finishing the game in style with a huge six off Shoriful Islam. Hope expressed satisfaction with the team's performance and emphasized the importance of every game in securing points for the 2027 World Cup qualification.

Earlier, Seales had a career-best performance, taking 4 wickets for 22 runs in nine overs. His brilliant spell saw him dismiss Soumya Sarkar, Litton Das, and Mehidy Hasan Miraz, reducing Bangladesh to 54-3. Mahmudullah, who scored 62 off 51 balls, and Tanzid Hasan (46) put up a fight,

in a stunning over, before adding the scalp of all-rounder Ellyse Perry (0) and Beth Mooney (0), leaving Australia struggling at 78 for 4.



However, Annabel Sutherland (110 off 95 balls) led a strong recovery for Australia, supported by Ashleigh Gardner (50) and captain Tahlia McGrath (56\*), as they powered Australia to

298/6 in 50 overs. Sutherland's century was particularly impressive, with her aggressive strokeplay shifting the momentum back in Australia's favor.

In India's response, Mandhana's century kept them in the hunt, but her dismissal at a critical point put an end to India's hopes. Despite a solid 39 from Harleen Deol, India's middle order faltered. Gardner's superb spell of 5 wickets for 30 runs tore through the lower order, with key players like Harmanpreet Kaur (12), Jemimah Rodrigues (16), and Deepti Sharma (0) failing to provide support.

India's poor fielding also cost them, as they dropped three difficult chances during the Australian innings. Despite Reddy's

heroics with the ball, India couldn't stop the Australian recovery, and the hosts cruised to a comfortable win to complete the series sweep.
