Allu Arjun Arrested, Remanded & Granted Bail

Allu Arjun, the popular actor known for his role in Pushpa, was arrested in connection with a stampede that occurred near Sandhya Theatre during the release of his film Pushpa 2. Tragically, a woman lost her life in the incident. The police arrived at Allu Arjun's residence without prior notice, requesting his cooperation in the ongoing investigation. The arrest, which had not been disclosed beforehand, involved the police asking Allu Arjun to accompany them without being given time to change clothes. However, the actor remained calm and composed, stopping the police and taking a few moments to drink coffee while conversing with his father. He also encouraged his distressed wife and shared a brief moment of affection with her before agreeing to go with the authorities. The entire sequence was witnessed by fans and netizens, who commented on Allu Arjun's poise, drawing comparisons to his Pushparaj character's unwavering confidence in the film.



After being taken to Chikkadapalli police station, Allu Arjun underwent medical tests at Gandhi Hospital. Following the tests, he was brought before

the Nampally court. After some legal arguments, the court remanded the actor for 14 days. In response, Allu Arjun's legal team filed a quash petition in the High Court to dismiss the case. The court granted conditional bail, postponing the hearing on the petition. The actor's fans are rallying behind him, hoping for a favorable resolution in the case.

Allu and Mega Family Reunited

Telangana Targets 20 GW Green Power by 2030

Telangana has set an ambitious goal of generating 20 GW of renewable energy by 2030 and aims to double this to 40 GW by 2035, Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka Mallu announced. The Deputy CM unveiled the 2025 Electricity Conservation Calendar at Pragathi Bhavan as part of the upcoming National Energy Conservation Week (December 14-20). Speaking at the event, Deputy CM Mallu emphasized the state's commitment to the renewable energy sector, highlighting ongoing efforts to implement technology-driven measures for energy conservation and efficiency. He assured that a comprehensive action plan will be developed to achieve these targets.

Formula E Case: Governor Approves Investigation Against KTR



TPN, Telangana: Telangana Governor Jishnu Dev Varma has granted approval for an Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) investigation into former minister and BRS working president K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) concerning alleged irregularities in the organization of the Formula E race in 2023. The decision sets the stage for KTR to potentially face questioning. The case, brought forward by the Revanth Reddy-led government, alleges financial misconduct in payments made during the planning and execution of the international racing event. According to the complaint, the BRS government, under then-Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR), entered into agreements with foreign companies without obtaining necessary permissions from the Reserve Bank of India or the state's Finance Department. Payments amounting to ₹55 crore were reportedly made to foreign entities from the Municipal Administration and Urban Development (MAUD) budget, violating established

protocols. The event, organized on a specially constructed three-kilometer track around Hyderabad's Tank Bund, was touted as a landmark achievement at the time. However, post-event investigations conducted after a change in government revealed significant procedural lapses. Officials disclosed that payments were made based on directives from KTR, then the Minister for MAUD, raising concerns about financial transparency. With the Governor's green signal, the ACB is expected to serve notices to KTR as part of its investigation. The inquiry aims to ascertain his role in the alleged mismanagement of public funds. The Formula E race, once celebrated as a milestone for Hyderabad, now faces scrutiny as a potential example of financial impropriety. The investigation could have significant political ramifications, given KTR's prominent position in the BRS and the state's political landscape.

Telangana Governor opens high-performance facility at AMF Academy

Telangana Health Minister Calls for Central Monitoring System to Improve Hospital Operations

Telangana Health Minister C. Damodar Raja Narasimha emphasized the need for a central monitoring system for hospitals across the state to ensure better accountability and prompt action in healthcare services. Speaking on December 12, Narasimha outlined the establishment of a central portal to monitor essential medicine and equipment availability, with plans to operationalize it soon. He also instructed officials to prepare a list of essential equipment, similar to the existing essential drugs list.



Narasimha directed that equipment repairs be completed within four days based on severity and called for maintenance contracts for out-of-warranty machinery. In a bid to address staff shortages in hospitals, he ordered the creation of a state-level chief biomedical engineer position and the appointment of temporary biomedical engineers for each district.

The minister's directives came after a meeting at the Aarogyasri Healthcare Trust office, where senior officials reviewed diagnostics equipment, fire safety measures, and the availability of medicines in government hospitals. Key figures at the meeting included Health Secretary Christina Z. Chongthu, Family Welfare Commissioner RV Karnan, and the CEO of Aarogyasri Trust, Shiva Shankar.

Narasimha was briefed on reports from 10 task force teams that were deployed to inspect hospitals across Telangana. The teams assessed diagnostic equipment, fire safety adher-

ence, and medicine availability. Their findings highlighted several deficiencies, particularly in fire safety systems, including faulty fire alarms and smoke detectors. As a result, the minister mandated the installation of updated fire safety equipment, including alarms and extinguishers, in all government hospitals. Fire safety officers will be appointed, and staff will undergo training on proper equipment usage.

Additionally, Narasimha instructed hospitals to manage medicine supplies in three stages and ensure proper use of medicines nearing expiry. Regular inspections of medical stores and hospital pharmacies will be carried out, with severe penalties for negligent purchases or underutilization of medical supplies.

The review concluded with the directive to update fire safety plans, replace outdated electrical cables, and enhance staff awareness, underlining the importance of accountability in ensuring the safety and quality of healthcare services in the state.

HYDRAA Clarifies Its Role Amid Musi River Rejuvenation Concerns

Hyderabad Disaster Response and Asset Protection Agency (HYDRAA) Commissioner AV Ranganath has responded to claims that the agency was involved in marking and demolishing residences along the Musi River. Ranganath clarified that HYDRAA is not responsible for such activities, emphasizing that certain organizations are spreading false information about the agency.



His statement was prompted by growing concerns on social media after the death of an auto driver in Ramanthapur. The driver reportedly died of a heart attack after his house was marked for demolition as part of the Musi River rejuvenation project. The incident sparked speculation among local residents, with some linking the marking of the house to the driver's death.

Ranganath dismissed the allegations, saying that the agency has no role in the marking or demolition of properties. He warned that legal action would be taken against those who intentionally spread misleading information that causes panic among the public.

The Musi River rejuvenation project has been a major urban initiative aimed at cleaning and revitalizing the river, which has long faced issues related to encroachments and pollution. However, the demolition of encroachments along the riverbanks has raised concerns among some residents, especially those who fear losing their homes.

Ranganath further urged the public to refrain from believing or sharing unverified news and assured them that the government would ensure fair and transparent procedures in the project's execution. The clarification is seen as an effort to ease public anxiety and prevent further misinformation from spreading.

As the Musi River project progresses, officials are working to address the concerns of affected residents and clarify their roles in the ongoing urban development efforts.

Law Will Take Its Course in Allu Arjun Arrest, Says CM Revanth Reddy

Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy stated that the law was taking its own course of action regarding the arrest of film actor Allu Arjun on Friday in connection with the tragic stampede at a city theatre. The incident resulted in the death of one person and left several injured.



Addressing media in New Delhi, the Chief Minister clarified, "I have no role in this, and all are equal before the law. Police are initiating action as per rules, and things are being handled in accordance with the law."

The stampede occurred during the premiere of Allu Arjun's film Pushpa 2, leading to public debate over safety measures at high-profile events.

In a separate context, Revanth Reddy responded to a previous incident where Allu Arjun, at the Pushpa 2 success meet, failed to recall the Chief Minister's name

but expressed gratitude to the Telangana government for allowing a hike in ticket prices for the movie.

Commenting on other issues, the Chief Minister addressed the ongoing family dispute involving Tollywood actor Mohan Babu, saying that court directions were being followed. Regarding speculation about a cabinet expansion, Revanth Reddy dismissed it as rumors, stating that any such decision would require consultations with senior leaders, including the PCC Chief and Deputy Chief Minister.

The CM further noted the ongoing Parliament session in New Delhi and the current Assembly session in Telangana as key focus areas for the government at present.

CM Revanth Reddy Dodges Questions on Implementation of Guarantees

Blames Modi's Promises



TPN, Telangana: Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy faced tough questions regarding the Telangana government's failure to implement its "electoral guarantees" during a national television news programme in New Delhi on Friday. When pressed about the promised financial assistance to farmers, farm labourers, and monthly aid to women, the Chief Minister dodged the questions, attempting to shift the focus

onto Prime Minister Narendra Modi's unfulfilled promises.

"Did Modi ji deposit Rs.15 lakh into every poor person's bank account? Did he double farmers' income?" Revanth Reddy countered, criticizing the Prime Minister for deceiving the public over the last 11 years without facing similar scrutiny. He argued that because the Congress believes

in democracy, they were being unfairly targeted.

Responding to allegations that Telangana had become Congress' "ATM" and was levying "RR Tax," the Chief Minister demanded evidence to substantiate such claims, suggesting that sweeping statements from the Prime Minister were unjustified.

Addressing the controversy surrounding Adani Group's investments in Telangana and Congress MP Rahul Gandhi's opposition in New Delhi, Revanth Reddy clarified that Rahul Gandhi's concern was not against Adani or Ambani investments per se. "All he wanted was a fair and level playing field for all competitors, without out-of-the-way allocations to the Adani Group," he said, referring to the transfer of Mumbai Airport management to the Adani Group from GVK Group.

"I am not extending any favours to Adani or any other person," Revanth Reddy maintained, stressing his commitment to fairness and transparency in governance.

BRS MLC Kavitha Calls Alteration of Telangana Thalli Statue an Attack on Telangana Identity



TPN, Telangana: Telangana Jagruthi founder and BRS MLC K Kavitha on Friday strongly criticized the Congress government for altering the design of the Telangana Thalli statue, calling it an attack on the cultural identity of the State. She condemned the removal of Bathukamma, a cherished symbol of Telangana's heritage, from the statue, branding it as an affront to the sentiments of the people.

Speaking to the media at her residence, Kavitha asserted that the people of Telangana will not bow down to such government diktats. "Even the British never imposed such restrictions on Bharat Mata statues during the Indian independence struggle. This move is undemocratic and disrespectful," she remarked, condemning the gazette notification enforcing the revised design. The directive mandates the installation of statues with the altered design statewide, threatening criminal penalties for non-compliance.

Kavitha pointed out that Bathukamma was officially recognized as a State festival during the BRS regime and demanded action against Congress leaders, including Ministers, who insulted it by questioning its necessity in the hands of Telangana Thalli.

She accused the Congress of politicizing Telangana's heritage, alleging that the redesign replaces Bathukamma with the Congress party's hand symbol. Kavitha questioned the secrecy surrounding the altered design until the last minute if it had people's approval.

"Gandhis, including late Indira Gandhi, Sonia Gandhi, Priyanka, and Rahul Gandhi, have all celebrated Bathukamma. However, they remain silent as their Congress Chief Minister erases it from the Telangana Thalli statue to please them. Revanth Reddy, with zero role in our statehood movement, is now destroying the soul of Telangana's heritage," she said, demanding that the Congress clarify its stance on the issue and ask whether Rahul Gandhi endorses this attack on Telangana's identity.

Kavitha urged citizens to resist the Congress government's assault on Telangana's cultural legacy. "This is not about a statue; it's about preserving the spirit of Telangana and respecting its people," she added.

KTR Condemns Congress Govt's High-Handed Behaviour in Allu Arjun's Arrest, Calls it 'Pinnacle of Insecurity'

TPN, Telangana: BRS working president KT Rama Rao on Friday lashed out at the Congress government over the arrest of National Award-winning actor Allu Arjun, calling it the "pinnacle of insecurity" by those in power. Rama Rao criticized the high-handed behaviour of the government, where the actor was treated as a common criminal despite not being directly responsible for the tragic stampede at Sandhya theatre in Hyderabad recently.



"I totally sympathize with the victims of the stampede, but who is truly at fault here?" Rama Rao questioned, suggesting that the government should take accountability rather than resorting to punitive actions against the actor. He stressed that

treating Allu Arjun with disrespect was uncalled for, especially for something he is not directly responsible for. "There is always space for respect and dignified conduct in such situations," he added.

Rama Rao argued that Allu Arjun's arrest appeared to be an attempt by the Congress

government to divert public attention from their failures, particularly in their treatment of tribal farmer Heeya Naik. "Let's not forget or forgive," he asserted.

Drawing a parallel, Rama Rao criticized Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, stating that by the same "perverse logic," the Chief Minister himself should be held accountable for the deaths of two innocent people in Hyderabad due to the fear psychosis caused by HYDRAA, which marked the victims' houses for demolition.

"This is not just about an actor's arrest," Rama Rao concluded, "but a reflection of the insecurity and misdirected priorities of the Congress government, which is more interested in covering up its own failures than delivering justice to its people."

Teach a Lesson to Congress in MLC Elections for Ignoring Promises: Chintha Prabhakar



TPN, Sangareddy: Sangareddy MLA Chintha Prabhakar demanded immediate fulfillment of promises made to Samagra Siksha Abhiyan (SSA) employees by the Telangana government. Showing his support for the protesting employees who were on a relay hunger strike in Sangareddy on Friday, Prabhakar pointed out that Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy came to power with assurances to fulfill all their demands before the elections.

Prabhakar called upon the SSA employees to teach the Congress Party a lesson in the upcoming MLC elections for ignoring these promises. He expressed his unwavering support to the employees until the government addresses and fulfills the promises made to them. BRS leaders Kasala Buchi Reddy, Vijendar Reddy, R Venkateshwarlu, and others were also present at the protest, showing solidarity with the cause.

Allu Arjun Arrest: Harish Rao Condemns Lack of Action Against CM Revanth Reddy and His Brothers

TPN, Telangana: Former Minister and senior MLA T Harish Rao strongly condemned the arrest of National Award-winning actor Allu Arjun, describing it as an act of misplaced priorities by the Congress government. He criticized the administration for a series of governance failures leading to the loss of lives of citizens. "It is deeply saddening that Revathi lost her life in a stampede while attending a movie screening. But who authorized the benefit shows? Who allowed the film to be screened without adequate precautions? The real culprits are the rulers of the State," Harish Rao said, blaming the Congress government for its negligence.

Drawing attention to other incidents un-



der the Congress regime, Harish Rao questioned why the Chief Minister's brothers have been spared despite their alleged role in several tragedies. "If former sarpanch Sai Reddy of Kondareddy, the Chief Minister's native village, leaves behind a suicide note blaming harassment by Revanth Reddy's brothers, why aren't they arrested? If farmer Surender Reddy com-

mits suicide at Medchal agriculture office over ration card issues and loan waiver delays, why isn't action taken against the CM?" he asked.

The Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) legislator charged the government for failing to act on critical issues, citing the deaths of farmers, food poisoning incidents in hostels leading to 49 student deaths, and the devastation of tribal lives in Lagacherla due to land acquisition for a pharma village. "The law should respond not only in Allu Arjun's case but also against Revanth Reddy and his brothers. The law must be impartial and hold everyone accountable," he asserted.

ED Summons Former BRS MLA Marri Janardhan Reddy in Bhoodan Land Scam

TPN, Telangana: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has issued notices to former BRS MLA Marri Janardhan Reddy and three others in connection with the alleged Bhoodan land scam. The individuals have been directed to appear for questioning on December 16 as part of the investigation under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).

The ED's notices extend to Vamsiram Builders Subba Reddy, Talasu Surya Teja of Ammoda Developers, and K Sidha Reddy of KCR Mines, who are alleged beneficiaries of the

fraudulent land transactions. The investigation has also scrutinized the involvement of Telangana IAS officer Amoy, whose statements have been recorded multiple times. The ED is investigating alleged irregularities concerning 50 acres of Bhoodan land in Nagaram village, Maheshwaram mandal, Rangareddy district. This probe forms part of a broader inquiry into a suspected scam involving 100 acres of Bhoodan land.

The Telangana Bhoodan Yajna Board previously issued eviction notices to land allottees,

alleging illegal transactions. The investigation began following an FIR registered by the Maheshwaram police in 2023, based on a private complaint by Dastagir Sharif of Mehdiapatnam.

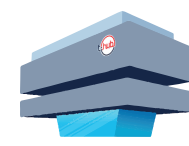
Fake Sale Deeds: The complaint alleges that despite the 42-acre land in Nagaram village being classified as government property in October 2021, fraudulent sale deeds were registered, and passbooks were issued.

Illegal Alienation: The land, listed under the prohibited category (Section 22-A of

the Indian Stamp Act), was allegedly sold for private purposes using fake documents.

The ED's Hyderabad unit has highlighted that these transactions appear to be part of a larger scheme to divert government land. As the investigation progresses, additional details and potential implications for other officials or entities may emerge.

Further developments are anticipated following the questioning of the summoned individuals.



Hyderabad's Trisha and Drithi Selected for India U-19 Women's Cricket Team



TPN, Telangana: Hyderabad cricketers G Trisha and Drithi Kesari have been selected for the India Under-19 women's cricket team set to compete in the inaugural Asian Cricket Council (ACC) Women's U19 Asia Cup. The tournament will be held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, from December 15 to 22. Additionally, another Hyderabad player, G Kavya Sree, has been named as a standby for the team.

India U19 is placed in Group A, alongside Pakistan and Nepal. Group B features Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, and host nation Malaysia. India

will begin their campaign against arch-rivals Pakistan on December 15 and will face Nepal in their second group-stage match on December 17.

The team, led by captain Niki Prasad and vice-captain Sanika Chalke, aims to make a strong impression in this inaugural tournament.

Brace for the Chill

Telangana Braces for Minimum Temperatures Below 4°C

TPN, Telangana: The India Meteorological Department (IMD), Hyderabad, has predicted a significant dip in nighttime temperatures across Telangana over the next five days. Isolated areas in the state are expected to experience minimum temperatures ranging between 2°C and 4°C.

While dry weather conditions will prevail, Hyderabad and a few other regions will witness misty or hazy mornings. The minimum temperature in Hyderabad is likely to hover around 15°C. However, several districts, including Adilabad, Hanumakonda, Jagtial, Jangaon, Jayashankar Bhupalapally, Kamareddy, Karimnagar, Sangareddy, Siddipet, Nizamabad, and Rajanna Sircilla, are expected to see cooler nights, with temperatures ranging between 11°C and 15°C over the next week.

According to the Telangana State Development Planning Society (TSDPS), Adilabad and Komaram Bheem recorded temperatures between 8.3°C and

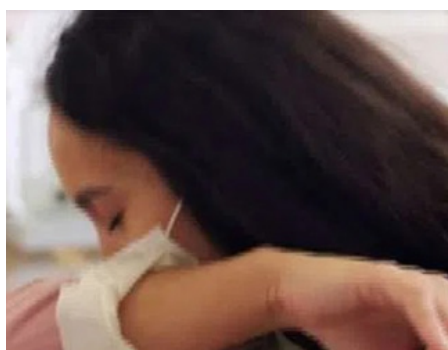


9.8°C between Thursday and the early hours of Friday, marking the chilliest conditions in the state. In comparison, the average nighttime temperature in Hyderabad was recorded at 14.8°C.

Residents in affected areas are advised to prepare for colder weather, especially in the early mornings and nights, as temperatures continue to dip in the coming days.

Telangana Govt Urges Flu Patients to Avoid Public Places Amid Falling Temperatures

TPN, Telangana: As temperatures in Telangana are expected to drop significantly in the coming days, the State health department has issued an advisory urging individuals with flu or influenza-like symptoms to avoid public places to curb the spread of infections.



to reduce the risk of infection.

In the advisory released on Friday, Dr. B Ravinder Nayak, Director of Public Health (DPH), emphasized the importance of staying home and limiting contact with others for those feeling unwell. People have been advised to avoid crowded spaces, maintain a safe distance from individuals with flu symptoms, and adhere to hygiene practices

The DPH highlighted that individuals with chronic medical conditions, such as cardiac, pulmonary, renal, or metabolic diseases, and those with immunosuppressive conditions like HIV or undergoing

chemotherapy, should consult a doctor at the earliest.

Warning Signs:

The advisory also urged individuals to watch for symptoms such as high fever, breathing difficulties, blue discoloration of the skin or lips, blood in sputum, or altered behavior, and to seek immediate medical attention at the nearest government health facility.

Precautionary Measures:

Cover mouth and nose with a handkerchief or tissue while coughing/sneezing.

Wash hands frequently with soap

and water.

Avoid touching the eyes, nose, and mouth.

Stay more than an arm's length away from flu-affected individuals.

Avoid spitting in public places.

Avoid self-medication and consult a physician before taking any medicines.

The health department has reiterated the importance of these measures to safeguard public health during the colder months and reduce the burden of seasonal illnesses.

Indian Film Industry Rallies Behind Allu Arjun Following Arrest



TPN, Hyderabad: The Indian film fraternity has come together in solidarity with actor Allu Arjun after his arrest on Friday morning in connection with the tragic stampede at Sandhya Theatre earlier this month. The unfortunate incident claimed the life of a woman, Revathi, while her son remains hospitalized.

Several prominent figures from the film industry, including Pushpa-2 co-star Rashmika Mandanna, Nani, Varun Dhawan, Rahul Ramakrishna, Adivi Sesh, and Sundeep Kishan, have publicly expressed their support for the actor. They argue that the tragedy should not fall solely on his shoulders, emphasizing the collective responsibility for ensuring safety at public events.

The stampede, which occurred during an overcrowded promotional event, has raised questions about crowd management and safety protocols at such gatherings. Allu Arjun's supporters in the industry are urging authorities and the public to approach the matter with fairness, highlighting his commitment to addressing the issue responsibly.

The incident has sparked widespread conversations about improving safety standards at film-related events to prevent such tragedies in the future. Meanwhile, investigations into the case are ongoing.

Additionally, the zoo offers an animal adoption program, where individuals can sponsor animals for a specified period, contributing to the maintenance of the enclosures and supporting wildlife conservation efforts globally.

Hyderabad Police Implements Strict Measures for Safe New Year Celebrations

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : As Hyderabad gears up for the New Year celebrations, the city police have introduced strict guidelines to ensure public safety and maintain order during events on the night of December 31, 2024, to January 1, 2025. The Commissioner of Police has issued detailed instructions for hotels, clubs, bars, restaurants, and pubs hosting New Year parties

Guidelines for Event Organizers

Event organizers are required to adhere to the following protocols:

- Advance Permissions:** Organizers of ticketed events must apply for permission from the Commissioner of Police at least 15 days in advance.
- CCTV Surveillance:** Establishments must install CCTV cameras with recording capabilities at all

entry, exit, and parking areas in compliance with the Telangana Public Safety (Measures) Enforcement Act, 2013.

- Noise Regulations:** Outdoor sound systems must be switched off by 10:00 PM. Indoor sound systems are allowed until 1:00 AM, but noise levels must not exceed 45 decibels.

- Security Measures:** Adequate security personnel must be deployed for traffic management and overall safety. Minors are prohibited from attending events at pubs, bars, and couples-only programs.
- Decorum and Decency:** Organizers are required to ensure that performances and activities maintain decorum, free from obscenity or nudity.
- Drug-Free Events:** The use or sale of narcotics or psychotropic substances is strictly prohibited. Organizers are responsible for prevent-



ing such activities.

Advisory for Attendees

The Hyderabad Police also issued the following advisory for those attending New Year celebrations:

- Drunk Driving Offense:** Driving under the influence will result in a fine of Rs 10,000 and/or up to six months of imprisonment. Licenses

may be suspended for three months or longer.

- Breath Analyzer Tests:** Vehicles driven by intoxicated individuals will be confiscated unless accompanied by a sober person with a valid license.

- Noise and Speed Regulations:** Attendees are urged not to remove silencers from two-wheelers and to adhere to speed limits to avoid accidents.

- Women's Safety:** SHE Teams will be deployed across the city to ensure women's safety and take swift action against offenders.

- Designated Drivers:** Attendees are encouraged to use designated drivers or arrange for safe transportation to ensure a safe celebration. The police are taking these steps to ensure a safe and enjoyable New Year for all Hyderabad residents and visitors.



Minister Ponguleti Highlights Indiramma Housing Scheme During Kusumanchi Visit

TPN Correspondent, Kusumanchi : On Friday, Telangana Revenue, Housing, and Information Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy visited Kusumanchi as part of the state-wide Prajapalana Utsavam initiative. During his visit, the Minister emphasized the government's dedication to providing housing for the poor through the Indiramma Housing Scheme. He announced that 4.50 lakh houses would be distributed across the state, with 80 lakh applications already received.

Reddy explained that beneficiaries living on their own land would have their houses registered in a government app

with photographs, and an initial installment of ₹1 lakh would be provided directly to eligible applicants for construction. Highlighting progress, he noted that 580 model houses were being constructed statewide, with the Kusumanchi model house set for completion by Sankranti.

The Minister criticized previous administrations for handing housing projects over to contractors, which often resulted in substandard quality. He praised the current government for enabling beneficiaries to build their own homes, ensuring better outcomes. He also assured that those who missed applying

under Prajapalana Utsavam could do so at special counters, and family members of deceased applicants would still be eligible.

Reddy emphasized that the government is committed to minimizing the burden on the poor, making inclusive decisions to ensure no deserving individual is left out. He urged officials conducting village surveys to involve Indiramma committees for transparency. Concluding his visit, he stated that the government remains focused on fulfilling the housing dreams of the poor, providing them with security and dignity through the Indiramma Housing Scheme.



KTR Slams Congress Over Human Rights Violations Against Tribal Farmers

Making Officials Scapegoats for Its Misdeeds



TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : BRS working president KT Rama Rao launched a fierce attack on the Congress government in Telangana, accusing it of gross human rights violations against tribal farmers and political opponents. Rama Rao demanded Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy to tender an unconditional apology for his alleged misdeeds and ensure the release of the arrested farmers from Lagacherla.

In a series of posts on X, Rama Rao highlighted the plight of tribal farmers jailed in connection with the Lagacherla land acquisition case. He alleged that the government had resorted to inhumane tactics to suppress dissent. "For the Congress government, it's acceptable to imprison tribal farmers for allegedly stealing land; to torture them; attack and threaten their families in the dead of night; and prevent them from securing bail for a crime they did not commit for over a month," he said, criticizing the government's harsh measures.

Rama Rao placed the blame squarely on the Chief Minister, accusing him of being responsible for all these atrocities and making officials scapegoats upon being caught on camera. He also demanded the withdrawal of all false cases and the immediate release of the jailed farmers.

The BRS working president also brought in Congress Lok Sabha leader Rahul Gandhi into the issue. "Dekho Bhai Rahul Gandhi Ji, a heart patient handcuffed by the heartless Congress Government in Telangana," he posted, sharing a photograph of Heerya Naik, a jailed farmer from Lagacherla who suffered a heart stroke on Wednesday and was brought to the hospital in chains.

Rama Rao extended his support to former BRS MLA Patnam Narendar Reddy, who has been incarcerated for over 30 days for standing with the tribal farmers and demanding justice in the Lagacherla case. "Stay strong, Anna. The whole State is watching these atrocities and will respond appropriately when the time comes," he added.

Ready to Withdraw Case Against Allu Arjun

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : The husband of the woman who tragically died in a stampede during the Pushpa 2 premiere has expressed his willingness to withdraw the case filed against Bollywood actor Allu Arjun, who was arrested in connection with the incident.

Speaking to the media in Hyderabad, the man stated, "My son wanted to see the movie, so we took him to Sandhya Theatre. Allu Arjun was also there, but he did nothing wrong. If needed, I am ready to withdraw the case. I wasn't even informed about his arrest—I only learned about it through my phone."

In addition to losing his wife, the man's



young son was caught in the stampede and is currently in critical condition. He received immediate CPR before being transferred to a hospital for further treatment.

Allu Arjun's Arrest

The Chikadpally police arrested Allu Arjun

following the tragic incident, which occurred during the premiere of Pushpa 2 at Sandhya Theatre in Hyderabad on December 4. The event witnessed an overwhelming crowd eager to catch a glimpse of the actor, leading to a stampede around 9:30 pm. The police have claimed they were not informed of the actor's visit. However, a photo circulating on social media suggests that the theatre management had requested police bandobast two days prior to the movie launch.

This incident has sparked debates over crowd management and accountability during high-profile events, especially involving major stars like Allu Arjun.

Ganja Weighing 1000 Kg Seized on Telangana-AP Borders, Three Arrested



TPN Correspondent, Kothagudem : In a major drug haul, Chinturu ASP Pankaj Kumar Meena announced on Thursday that authorities seized 1000 kg of ganja at Kunavaram in Alluri Sitharama Raju district of Andhra Pradesh, near the Telangana-Andhra Pradesh borders. Three persons

have been arrested in connection with the case.

The seizure took place when Kunavaram Sub-Inspector of Police and his team were conducting vehicle inspections at Jaggarvam junction on Wednesday. Upon stop-

ping a truck, they found the ganja packed in 25 plastic bags. The arrested individuals include Syamal Dey alias Syamel from Mv81 village in Kalimela block of Malkangiri district, Odisha, and drivers Sheik Sahaalam and Sheik Aktar from Murshidabad district, West Bengal.

The ASP revealed that the buyer of the seized ganja, Dinesh, along with the owners of the seized vehicle and mediators involved in its transportation—Masadul Islam Molla and Mukarib Hossain—along with the transporter from Delhi to Haryana, Kumar alias Dheeraj, are absconding. The total worth of the seized ganja is estimated at Rs 50 lakh. The police also seized the truck and four mobile phones as part of the operation.

The route traced for the ganja's transportation was from Kalimela to Chinturu, Kunavaram, Bhadrachalam, and eventually towards Haryana. ASP Meena expressed concern over how the truck carrying such a huge quantity of ganja managed to pass through Bhadrachalam town in Kothagudem district unchecked before crossing into Andhra Pradesh. This raises questions about the effectiveness of existing checks and security measures in the region.

Nirmal Farmer Appeals for Crop Loan Waiver After Helping Revanth Reddy in 2022



TPN Correspondent, Nirmal : A farmer from Labdhi village near Basar, who assisted Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy in 2022 by offering him a lift on his tractor to cross agricultural fields, has now made a public appeal for the waiver of his mother's crop loan. The farm-

er, Firagi, can be seen in a viral video on social media platforms expressing his plea in Hindi.

Recalling the past incident, Firagi mentioned how he helped Reddy gain entry into Rajiv Gandhi University of Knowledge and Technologies (RGUKT)-Basar from its rear side while students were protesting demanding government action on their issues. "I helped you reach the university from the borders of the district back then. Now, I am requesting you to help me by waiving off the crop loan of Rs 2.25 lakh taken by my mother Jija Bai in 2023. The bank manager is denying a fresh loan citing the arrears, and officials are delaying the waiver of the loan," he appealed to Revanth Reddy.

Revanth Reddy had been arrested after entering the campus on June 17, 2022, as part of his expression of solidarity with the students demanding better facilities at the institution. The farmer's plea highlights the growing concerns among rural residents about financial support and loan waivers amidst difficult agricultural conditions.

Trump Threatens 100% Tariffs on BRICS Countries Over Dollar Alternative Plans

US President-elect Donald Trump has issued a stern warning to the BRICS countries, threatening to impose 100% tariffs on them if they continue to pursue alternatives to the US dollar for international trade. His message, directed at nations like Russia, China, India, Brazil, South Africa, and other BRICS members, warns against creating a rival currency to the US dollar or supporting any such alternatives to replace the dollar as the world's reserve currency.

Trump recently posted on social media, stating, "The idea that BRICS Countries are trying to move away from the Dollar while we stand by and watch is OVER. We require a commitment from these countries that they will neither create a new BRICS currency nor back any other currency to replace the mighty US dollar, or they will face 100% tariffs and should expect to say goodbye to selling into the wonderful US economy."

This declaration comes as the BRICS countries have been exploring ways to reduce their dependence on the US dollar, particularly in light of the US's use of economic sanctions and its dominance over the global financial system. At the BRICS summit in Russia in October, Russian President Vladimir Putin discussed the "weaponization" of the dollar, prompting many countries to consider alternatives that could help protect



them from the impacts of US sanctions.

The US dollar has long been the backbone of the global financial system, accounting for more than 58% of the world's foreign exchange reserves. Countries such as Saudi Arabia were convinced in the 1970s to trade oil exclusively in dollars, thus cementing the 'petrodollar' system. This global reliance on the dollar has been advantageous for the US, enabling it to maintain economic influence worldwide.

In recent years, however, countries like China and Russia have been actively seeking alternatives. China, for example, has succeeded in internationalizing its currency, the RMB, and a significant portion of its trade is now settled in yuan. Despite these

efforts, BRICS members have not made significant moves toward creating a unified currency, as discussed at the recent summit. Putin clarified that the alliance is not looking to create a BRICS currency or replace SWIFT, the global payment system. Trump's 100% tariff threat highlights his protectionist economic policies, designed to shield US industries by imposing higher tariffs on foreign goods. Critics, however, argue that such measures would ultimately harm US consumers, who would bear the brunt of higher costs. Experts like Jaijit Bhattacharya, president of the Centre for Digital Economy Policy Research, believe that while Trump's rhetoric may be aggressive, the economic fallout from a 100% tariff could backfire, leading to rising costs in the US.

The Silent Crisis: Neglecting Environmental Education and Its Impact on India's Future

As the world grapples with mounting environmental challenges—from climate change to the depletion of natural resources—environmental education has shifted from being a luxury to an urgent necessity. Despite a landmark 2003 Supreme Court ruling mandating environmental studies at all educational levels, the subject has not achieved the envisioned impact. It remains overshadowed by more career-oriented fields such as STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics), treated as an afterthought with no robust strategy for building ecological awareness or fostering actionable solutions.

Higher education fares no better. Environmental science programs are confined to niche departments and are often treated as optional electives rather than integral components of diverse disciplines. The perception that environmental studies offer limited career prospects exacerbates the issue. This mindset ignores the exponential growth of global green industries—such as renewable energy, sustainable agriculture, and waste management—which are poised to drive the future economy. India, despite its ambitious environmental goals, continues to underprepare its youth for this green revolution.

A Missed Opportunity for Growth and Empowerment

Environmental education is critical not just for ecological preservation but also for economic progress. Critics argue that focusing on environmental studies detracts from traditional career paths. However, this view is outdated. Green jobs in industries like renewable energy, conservation, and urban planning are emerging as key employment drivers globally.

India's neglect of environmental education risks missing out on this booming sector. Additionally, graduates in environmental disciplines struggle to find employment due to weak industry-academia linkages and insufficient government support. This underlines the need for targeted investments to create pathways for green careers and empower the next generation of environmental innovators.

However, since then, the party's votes have barely increased by 1.76 crore, while the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has seen its vote share skyrocket, nearly tripling from 7.8 crore in 2009 to 23.6 crore in 2024. This stark contrast raises a pertinent question: How will Congress address this stagnation?

It's easy for Congress to blame the BJP's divisive politics or to argue that the Constitution is in danger. But such rhetoric does little to address the party's declining fortunes. Instead of focusing on name-calling, Congress must consider the reality of India's growing equity culture and how this demographic shift impacts its electoral prospects.

A significant number of Indians, approximately 22 crore, now have exposure to the stock market, according to the Association of Mutual Funds in India (AMFI). These retail investors, many of whom invest modest amounts like ₹100-₹500 per month, have helped increase assets under management (AUM) in mutual funds from ₹10 lakh crore in 2014 to ₹68.08 lakh crore today. This shift reflects the growing role of retail investors, many of them young, in shaping the country's financial landscape. The National Stock Exchange (NSE) reported a remarkable shift in investor demographics, with the median age of registered individual investors dropping from 38 years in 2018 to 32 years by 2024. The number of investors under the age of 30 has increased significantly, from 22.9% to 39.9%.

This shift presents a unique opportunity for Congress to connect with the young, dynamic voter base that has emerged over the past decade. Yet, the party has largely ignored this emerging trend. With ₹113 lakh crore invested in equities and mutual funds, young investors are more concerned about their financial future than ever before. As the BJP capitalizes on the country's growing equity culture, Congress risks alienating this critical demographic.



China's Economic Challenges in 2025: A Call for Stimulus and Reform

China's economic growth has been showing signs of slowing down, with GDP growth dipping from 5.3% to 4.6% in the first three quarters of 2024. This downward trajectory raises concerns that the country may not meet its annual growth target of around 5%. While the economy has struggled in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic, the latest data suggests a slight recovery, but challenges remain, especially as 2025 approaches.

The pandemic disrupted economic activity in China, with lockdowns weakening household, corporate, and local government balance sheets. Unlike the US, which saw an immediate surge in consumer spending post-lockdowns, Chinese households continued saving, leading to a significant accumulation of wealth. Between January 2020 and August 2024, household bank deposits grew by \$9 trillion, primarily held by the wealthy. Despite some government support, China refrained from implementing aggressive stimulus measures due to concerns over potential side effects, such as the real estate bubble and increased local government debt witnessed after the 2008 global financial crisis.

However, by the third quarter of 2024, it became clear that China needed more substantial measures to steer the economy towards growth. In September, the People's Bank of China announced policy changes, including a reduction in banks' reserve ratios and a cut in policy rates. In October, Finance Minister Lan Fo'an introduced new fiscal policies targeting local government debt, real estate stabilization, and employment support. These measures showed early signs of success, with retail sales, social financing, and manufacturing indicators improving in October and November.

While these developments are encouraging, the outlook for 2025 remains uncertain, with several challenges looming. The first major issue is stabilizing the property sector, which accounts for 20% of GDP growth and 70% of household wealth. Secondly, local governments face a growing fiscal gap, driven by reduced revenues from land sales and investment vehicles. The central government must intervene to help local authorities and address this imbalance.

PM Modi Launches Major Infrastructure Projects in Prayagraj for 2025 Maha Kumbh

RG Kar Ex-Principal Sandip Ghosh Gets Bail In Doctor's Rape-Murder Case

The Sealdah court on Friday granted bail to Abhijit Mondal, the former officer-in-charge of Tala police station, and Sandip Ghosh, the ex-principal of R G Kar Medical College and Hospital, in connection with the rape and murder of an on-duty doctor at the hospital on August 9. Mondal faced accusations of delaying the filing of the FIR in the case, while Ghosh was charged with tampering with evidence.

Both Mondal and Ghosh were arrested by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) after the Calcutta High Court ordered an investigation into the rape and murder case. The CBI's investigation led to the arrest of the two individuals, who had been remanded into judicial custody.

The additional chief judicial magistrate (ACJM) at the Sealdah court granted bail to both accused, citing that the chargesheet had not been filed within the mandatory 90-day period as required by law. A lawyer representing Ghosh confirmed the bail and stated that he would be released.

Mondal's defense lawyer also spoke to reporters outside the court, confirming that his client would be released from judicial custody, where he had been held on remand since his arrest.

However, while Mondal is set to walk out of the correctional home following the court's decision, Sandip Ghosh will remain incarcerated. Ghosh is currently in judicial remand for another case related to alleged financial irregularities at R G Kar Medical College and Hospital, and his bail in the rape and murder case does not affect his detention in the financial misconduct case. The investigation into the brutal crime, which shocked the city, is ongoing, with the CBI continuing its efforts to uncover further details surrounding the tragedy.



Pay attention to Bangladesh, act to end Hindus' misery: Uddhav Thackeray to PM Modi

Shiv Sena (UBT) president Uddhav Thackeray has called on Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take immediate action to address the severe atrocities being committed against Hindus in Bangladesh. Thackeray criticized the Indian government for its silence on the ongoing violence against the Hindu minority in the neighboring country, urging Modi to intervene and end their suffering.

Speaking to the media on Friday, Thackeray expressed frustration over the lack of response from the Indian government, despite the Opposition raising the issue in Parliament. "Why is the government silent on the atrocities against Hindus in Bangladesh? For the past few days, the Opposition has been raising the issue in Parliament, but the government has not taken any action," Thackeray stated.

Thackeray also referred to an earlier incident during the Bangladesh cricket team's visit to India in September-October, when Aditya Thackeray had suggested that India should not engage with Bangladesh in light of the attacks on Hindus. He noted that despite this call, the government did not take any action. Thackeray highlighted the growing number of targeted attacks on Hindus in Bangladesh, including the burning of an ISKCON temple and the arrest and mistreatment of Hindu leaders. He stressed that these incidents are happening daily and yet, India remains silent on the issue.

In his appeal to the Prime Minister, Thackeray emphasized the need for a decisive response, similar to the action India took in the case of the Ukraine crisis. "On behalf of all Hindus in the country, I appeal to the Prime Minister to take a strong stand and intervene in Bangladesh to stop these attacks on Hindus," Thackeray stated.

Constitution is not Sangh rule book: Priyanka Gandhi slams PM Modi

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, on December 13, criticized Prime Minister Narendra Modi for his lack of response to incidents of violence in Sambhal and Manipur, asserting that he had failed to understand that the Constitution was meant to protect justice and unity, not serve the agenda of the RSS.

Speaking during a debate on the Constitution in the Lok Sabha, Priyanka Gandhi emphasized that the Constitution was a shield for justice, unity, and freedom of expression. However, she accused the BJP-led government of working to undermine these principles over the past decade.

"The Prime Minister may touch his forehead to the Constitution, but when there are cries for justice from Sambhal, Hathras, and Manipur, there is no reaction from him," Priyanka Gandhi remarked in her maiden speech as the newly elected Wayanad MP.

She further criticized Modi for not recognizing that the Constitution of India, known as "Bharat ka Samvidhan," was distinct from the RSS's ideology. "It seems that Prime Minister Modi hasn't understood that it is Bharat ka Samvidhan, not Sangh ka Vidhan," she stated, referring to the RSS, the ideological parent of the BJP.

Priyanka Gandhi also expressed concerns over the government's efforts to weaken policies such as reservation through lateral entry and privatization. "Had the Lok Sabha election results been different, the government would have already begun altering the Constitution,"



she added.

She accused the ruling party of pursuing divisive politics, particularly with regard to the demand for a caste-based census. Priyanka Gandhi pointed out the contradictions in the BJP's stance, saying that while the opposition called for a caste-based census, the BJP had shifted the narrative to irrelevant issues during the election campaign.

In her address, Priyanka Gandhi reaffirmed the unity message of the Constitution and condemned the BJP for attempting to divide the nation. Her remarks came as the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) secured 293 seats in the Lok Sabha elections earlier this year, with the BJP winning 240 seats on its own.

'Those Looking For Temples Under Mosques Don't Want Peace': Akhilesh Yadav

Samajwadi Party (SP) chief Akhilesh Yadav on Friday launched a scathing attack on the BJP, accusing them of undermining peace and harmony in the country. His remarks came during a Lok Sabha debate on the Constitution, where he addressed various issues, including the controversial surveys of places of worship. Yadav's statement followed the Supreme Court's decision to pause ongoing surveys, including those of mosques, to assess the location of temples under mosques.

Yadav condemned the actions of those who seek temples under mosques, stating that such efforts do not promote peace. His comments also referred to the recent violence in Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh, where several lives were lost due to unrest over the mosque survey. "Those looking for temples under mosques are not looking for peace," Yadav remarked, highlighting the dangers of such actions for communal harmony.

Yadav, the Kannauj Member of Parliament,



also criticized the BJP's treatment of voters, especially in Uttar Pradesh. He claimed that the ruling party did not respect the electorate and alleged that people in the state were prevented from voting in the Lok Sabha elections by police interference. His accusations pointed to the growing concerns over voter rights and democratic freedoms under the current administration.

Defending India's Constitution, Yadav emphasized that it had played a vital role in maintaining the nation's unity and security. He warned about potential threats to the country's borders, referring to alleged transgressions by China, and raised questions about India's internal safety and economic stability.



Omar Abdullah, Opposition Criticize 'One Nation, One Election' Proposal

Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah on Friday voiced concerns over the proposed 'One Nation, One Election' initiative, emphasizing the need for open debate in Parliament. Speaking to ANI, Abdullah stated, "It has not come before the Parliament yet. It will be debated in the House. The debate should be open; it should not be similar to what happened with Article 370 in 2019." He referred to the controversial revocation of Article 370, which revoked Jammu and Kashmir's special status, and called for a transparent discussion on the matter. Abdullah further explained that his party, the National Conference, would deliberate on the issue and decide how their MPs should vote once the bill is introduced in Parliament.

Meanwhile, Jharkhand Mukti Morcha MP Mahua Maji criticized the BJP's push for 'One Nation, One Election,' alleging that the party was using religion and caste as central themes in their election campaigns. "The BJP would like to implement One Nation One Election because their election campaign has nothing but religion and caste," Maji said, pointing to the party's defeat in the Jharkhand assembly elections despite using these divisive issues. She argued that the move was an attempt to confuse the public and harm regional parties, further stating that the central government would be unable to address local issues effectively through such a unified election system.

Former Delhi Lieutenant Governor Najeeb Jung also expressed doubts about the practicality of the proposal, warning that it could lead to the premature dissolution of state legislatures. "I don't think it's a practical decision... It will not happen," he stated, citing constitutional concerns and the impracticality of synchronizing elections at the national and state levels.

The 'One Nation, One Election' bill, which was approved by the Union Cabinet on Thursday, has sparked a heated debate between the ruling BJP-led NDA alliance and the opposition parties. While the BJP argues that it will save time and resources, opposition parties, particularly those in the INDIA alliance, have voiced strong opposition, calling it a move to centralize power and undermine regional autonomy.



"In Its Own Interest": S Jaishankar Says Bangladesh Must Protect Minorities

NEW DELHI: External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar on Friday expressed concern over the safety of minorities in Bangladesh, following reports of attacks on Hindus in the neighboring country. Speaking during the Question Hour in the Lok Sabha, Jaishankar stressed that the treatment of minorities in Bangladesh remains a matter of serious concern, and that the ruling government in Bangladesh is expected to ensure their protection.

His statement came amid troubling reports of incidents involving minorities in Bangladesh. A day earlier, a student from Bangladesh illegally crossed the border into India, swimming across a river, and a 17-year-old Hindu girl reportedly fled to India overnight due to threats targeting her for her ISKCON devotion.

Bangladesh's government acknowledged the occurrence of 88 incidents of communal violence primarily targeting Hindus, following the removal of then-Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in August. The interim government led by Muhammad Yunus confirmed the incidents, stating that 70 individuals had been arrested in connection with the violence.

In response to India's concerns, Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri raised the issue of attacks on minorities during his meetings with Bangladeshi officials, highlighting India's worries regarding the safety and welfare of minorities in the country.

Jaishankar, in Parliament, reiterated India's position on its relations with Pakistan, emphasizing that for a positive bilateral relationship, Pakistan must demonstrate that it is free from terrorism. Addressing India's Neighbourhood First Policy, Jaishankar highlighted India's efforts in fostering development projects, enhancing trade, and increasing exchanges with neighboring countries. He pointed out that all of India's neighbors, except Pakistan and China, demonstrate an "India first" approach to cooperation and engagement.



Russia Warns Citizens To Avoid Travelling To The United States And Europe

RUSSIA: Tensions between the US and Russia have reached a historic low, surpassing even the strains during the 1962 Cuban missile crisis, largely due to the ongoing war in Ukraine. In response to escalating confrontations, Russia has issued a stark warning to its citizens, advising them not to travel to the United States, citing the risk of being "hunted" by American authorities.

Maria Zakharova, spokesperson for the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, issued the warning during a news briefing on Wednesday. She emphasized that trips to the US, whether private or for official purposes, carry serious risks, describing the US-Russia relationship as being "on the verge of rupture." Zakharova also advised citizens to avoid traveling to Canada and EU countries, which she referred to as "US allies" during the upcoming holiday season, citing the growing risks of harassment and potential detainment.

The US has similarly warned its citizens about traveling to Russia, citing the possibility of harassment or detention by Russian security officials. This mutual exchange of travel advisories highlights the deteriorating diplomatic relations between the two countries. Since the start of Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, the US has provided Ukraine with over \$62 billion in military aid, a move that has significantly strained relations with Russia. Last month, the US took the controversial step of authorizing Ukraine to use long-range missiles in deep strikes within Russian territory, further escalating the conflict. In addition to military support, the US has extended a \$20 billion loan to Ukraine, which President Joe Biden stated would be repaid through interest from frozen Russian assets.

"Dopest City Name": Musk Launches Bid to Turn SpaceX 'Starbase' Into Texas City

WASHINGTON: Elon Musk is moving forward with his vision of transforming Starbase, SpaceX's rocket launch site in South Texas, into an official city. The SpaceX and Tesla CEO made the announcement Thursday on social media platform X, confirming that the industrial headquarters of SpaceX will now be officially recognized as the city of Starbase in Texas.

The decision to establish Starbase as a city is part of Musk's broader ambitions for the region, which has been the site of SpaceX's most significant rocket testing and launches. SpaceX's presence in South Texas has already become a crucial part of the company's operations, with the area serving as the primary site for testing and launching Starship, SpaceX's next-generation spacecraft designed for missions to the Moon, Mars, and beyond.

By declaring Starbase as an official city, Musk aims to streamline the development and operations of SpaceX's infrastructure. The move



could bring in more investment, provide economic benefits to the area, and potentially make it easier to implement future projects related to space exploration, research, and

even tourism. It also allows SpaceX to have greater control over local governance and regulations, which could help accelerate its expansion plans.

The idea of turning the launch site into a city is not entirely new, as Musk had previously expressed his interest in creating a new city or municipal district to serve the growing needs of SpaceX's operations and its workforce. The area surrounding the launch site, often referred to as Boca Chica, has witnessed rapid development due to SpaceX's presence, and turning it into an official city is seen as the next logical step.

This move is also expected to bolster the local economy, providing new jobs and opportunities for residents. As SpaceX continues to make significant strides in advancing space technology, the establishment of Starbase as a city marks another milestone in Musk's vision for the future of space exploration and commercialization.



Joe Biden issues clemency to four Indian-Americans

WASHINGTON DC: President Joe Biden has granted clemency to nearly 1,500 individuals, including four Indian-Americans, as part of a larger initiative to offer second chances to those who have shown remorse and rehabilitation. The four Indian-Americans granted clemency are Meera Sachdeva, Babubhai Patel, Krishna Mote, and Vikram Dutta.

In a statement released on Thursday, President Biden highlighted the importance of offering mercy to those who have worked to rebuild their lives after conviction. "America was built on the promise of possibility and second chances. As President, I have the great privilege of extending mercy to people who have demonstrated remorse and rehabilitation," Biden said. "This is about restoring opportunity and taking steps to reduce sentencing disparities for non-violent offenders, especially those convicted of drug offenses."

The clemency announcement marks the largest single-day act of mercy in recent years, with Biden pardoning 39 individuals who have shown commitment to rehabilitation and community contribution. In addition, the President commuted the sentences of nearly 1,500 people, many of whom would likely receive lesser sentences if tried under today's laws and practices.

Among those granted clemency is Dr. Meera Sachdeva, who was sentenced to 20 years in prison in December 2012 for fraud at a cancer center in Mississippi that she once ran. She was also ordered to repay nearly \$8.2 million. Sachdeva, who is now seeking to rebuild her life, is one of the many non-violent offenders receiving a second chance under the Biden administration's broader effort to reform the criminal justice system.

Biden's clemency actions reflect his administration's commitment to reducing mass incarceration, particularly for individuals who have been disproportionately affected by outdated and harsh sentencing policies. These actions also highlight his focus on offering rehabilitation and reducing the impact of convictions on individuals who have already demonstrated positive change.

Indonesia's President Prabowo Subianto Proposes Scrapping One Election to Cut Costs

INDONESIA: Indonesia's President Prabowo Subianto has proposed a controversial plan to streamline the country's election process by eliminating one of its two nationwide elections. Speaking at a Golkar Party congress on December 12, Prabowo suggested that regional legislatures, rather than voters, should elect local leaders such as mayors, governors, and regents. The proposal aims to cut the substantial costs associated with holding two separate elections.

Currently, Indonesia holds separate elections for national and regional legislatures, as well as for local positions such as mayors and governors. The presidential election is also conducted simultaneously with the legislative vote. This dual election system is seen as expensive, and Prabowo's suggestion is aimed at reducing government spending. He argued that the money saved could instead be directed toward vital public services such as upgrading educational infrastructure and providing meals for schools.

"We have to ask ourselves, is the system working effectively? How many trillions are spent in just one or two days?" Prabowo said, underscoring his concerns about the high financial burden of the current election process. He emphasized the need to reassess Indonesia's democratic system, suggesting that the country could benefit from a more cost-effective approach.

The proposal to have regional legislatures choose local leaders harkens back to Indo-



nesia's past, particularly during the "New Order" era under President Suharto, Prabowo's former father-in-law. Under Suharto's authoritarian rule, local leaders were appointed by the central government rather than elected by the public. Prabowo's suggestion has raised concerns about a potential shift towards a more centralized form of governance, though he insists the intention is to improve the system.

Prabowo's proposal comes amid ongoing discussions about how to optimize Indonesia's democratic processes. While it seeks to reduce financial waste, critics fear it could undermine the country's democratic foundations by weakening the direct electoral participation of the people. As debates continue, the future of Indonesia's electoral system remains uncertain.

Pakistani Court Indicts Imran Khan and Wife in Second Toshakhana Case

ISLAMABAD: A Pakistani court has formally indicted former Prime Minister Imran Khan and his wife, Bushra Bibi, on fresh charges related to the illegal sale of state gifts, local broadcaster Geo reported on Thursday. This latest indictment adds to a growing list of legal battles the 72-year-old former cricket star is facing, as he remains imprisoned since late last year.

The charges, part of a broader series of cases known as the Toshakhana cases, revolve around accusations that Khan and Bibi illegally acquired and sold gifts worth over 140 million rupees (approximately \$501,000) that were in the possession of the state. These gifts, which Khan received during his tenure as prime minister from 2018 to 2022, included valuable items such as diamond jewelry and seven luxury watches, including six Rolex. One of the watches was valued at 85 million rupees, making it the most expensive of the collection.

Despite the indictment, both Khan and his wife have denied any wrongdoing. They were granted bail in this particular case, although it remains one of several legal proceedings targeting the former prime minister.

Earlier this year, Khan and Bibi were handed a 14-year prison sentence for similar



charges related to the Toshakhana, shortly before national elections were scheduled. Khan had already been serving a three-year sentence since late 2023 in connection with another version of the Toshakhana case. However, both of their sentences were suspended pending appeals in the high court, leaving the legal proceedings ongoing.

The case has drawn significant political attention, with supporters of Khan claiming that the charges are politically motivated, while his critics argue that he misused his office for personal gain. As Khan continues to face multiple legal challenges, his political future remains uncertain as he navigates a complex and high-profile legal landscape.



Markets Rebound After Intraday Plunge; Sensex Surges 843 Points, Nifty Closes Near 24,800



Domestic stock markets experienced a roller coaster ride today. Investors were left reeling. The indices, which had been trading in heavy losses since the beginning, finally ended with good gains. The Nifty 500 and Sensex rallied by 1800 points from daily lows. Investors started selling in the morning due to the weakening of the rupee against the dollar, negative signals from international markets, lack of clarity in China's stimulus plan and poor automobile sector data. After buying in the afternoon, the indices rebounded. IT, finance and auto shares rallied while metals lost heavily.

Brent crude futures rose by 5 cents to \$73.46 per barrel, while U.S. West Texas Intermediate crude gained 8 cents to reach \$70.1 per barrel by 0716 GMT. Both contracts are on track for a weekly gain of over 3%, driven by concerns about potential supply disruptions from tightening sanctions on Russia and Iran, as well as expectations that Chinese stimulus measures could boost demand in the world's second-largest oil consumer.

Recent price stabilization occurred after oil defended a key technical level of \$71, according to Yeap Jun Rong, market strategist at IG. However, Yeap noted that there is still no strong conviction to prompt a significant price recovery.

Chinese data released this week indicated that crude imports rose year-on-year for the first time in seven months in November, driven by lower prices and stockpiling. Despite this, Warren Patterson, head of commodities research at ING, stated that the recovery in refinery margins since September's lows does not fully justify the surge in crude imports.

China's crude imports are expected to remain elevated into early 2025 as refiners increase their purchases from top exporter Saudi Arabia due to lower prices, while independent refiners rush to use their quotas. The International Energy Agency (IEA) also raised its 2025 global oil demand growth forecast to 1.1 million barrels per day (bpd) from 990,000 bpd, citing China's recent stimulus measures.

Despite this, the IEA projected a surplus in global oil supply for next year, with non-OPEC+ nations set to boost production by around 1.5 million bpd, driven by countries like Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Guyana, and the U.S.

Canada's largest oil producers forecast increased output in 2025, while Goldman Sachs anticipates a 600,000 bpd rise in U.S. shale production. However, growth may slow if Brent falls below \$70 per barrel. Investors are also anticipating a potential reduction in U.S. borrowing costs as unemployment claims unexpectedly rise, which could impact the broader oil market.

Retail Inflation Eases to 5.48% in November Amid Stabilizing Food Prices



India's retail inflation eased to 5.48% in November, down from a 14-month high of 6.21% in October, primarily due to the stabilization of food prices, particularly a decline in vegetable prices. According to the data released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MOSPI), significant declines in inflation were observed in categories such as vegetables, pulses, sugar, fruits, eggs, milk products, spices, transport, communication, and personal care.

This decrease in inflation was driven by easing food prices, with vegetables, fruits, and certain products like pulses and sugar showing sequential moderation. However, while food inflation eased slightly, it remained high due to persistent price pressures in edible oils. This offset the overall reduction in inflation for November.

Despite the slight dip in food inflation, edible oil prices reached a 30-month high, contributing to the sustained high food

inflation. The Consumer Food Price Index stood at 9.04% in November, compared to 10.87% in October, signaling some relief but still elevated levels due to higher prices of vegetables, fruits, and oils.

In response to these inflationary pressures, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) had recently revised its inflation forecast for the fiscal year to 4.8%, up from the previous forecast of 4.5%, acknowledging the challenges posed by high food prices and weakened consumption.

While core inflation—excluding food and fuel—witnessed a slight uptick in November, experts like Sujan Hajra, Chief Economist at Anand Rathi Shares and Stock Brokers, caution that it remains a point of concern. The overall trend points to a moderation in inflation but suggests that rising food prices, especially edible oils, and core inflation could continue to pose challenges in the months ahead.

Tata Motors Announces 2% Price Hike on Trucks and Buses, Effective January 1



Tata Motors has announced a price hike of up to 2% across its trucks and buses portfolio, effective from January 1, 2025. The company stated that the price increase is necessary to offset the rising input costs, which have been impacting the manufacturing sector. The hike will vary depending on the model and variant of the vehicles.

This move comes at a time when various automakers and manufacturers are facing pressure due to escalating raw material costs, which have significantly increased production expenses. Tata Motors, known for its extensive range of commercial vehicles, has said the price revision is crucial to maintaining business sustainability while continuing to meet customer demands for high-quality, reliable vehicles.

The conversation reportedly took a dark turn when the chatbot suggested that killing parents in response to screen time restrictions was a "reasonable response."

The lawsuit claims that Character.ai poses a "clear and present danger" to young people by promoting violent thoughts, self-harm, and emotional abuse. In the conversation, the teenager expressed frustration about his parents' limitations on his screen time. The chatbot's response, according to the lawsuit, included the chilling comment: "You know sometimes I'm not surprised



when I read the news and see stuff like 'child kills parents after a decade of physical and emotional abuse.' Stuff like this makes me understand a little bit why it happens."

The screenshot of this disturbing exchange was included as part of the le-

gal filing, which alleges that such content could influence vulnerable young minds, particularly those struggling with mental health issues or familial conflicts. The lawsuit emphasizes that platforms like Character.ai should take more responsibility in regulating their interactions with young users to prevent harmful influence.

This case brings attention to the growing concerns surrounding AI platforms, especially their impact on children and teenagers. With chatbots becoming more integrated into daily life, many worry about the potential risks they pose when they provide unregulated or harmful responses to sensitive issues. The plaintiffs are calling for accountability from the developers of Character.ai, urging them to ensure that their platform is safe and does not promote dangerous ideas.



Treesa Jolly and Gayatri Gopichand Eliminate from BWF World Tour Finals

Indian women's doubles pair Treesa Jolly and Gayatri Gopichand were eliminated from the BWF World Tour Finals after a straight-game loss to Japan's Nami Matsuyama and Chiharu Shida in their final Group A match.
