RPSISODIA WILL BE NEW CHIEF SECRETARY?

RP Sisodia may be the new Chief Secretary to the Government of Andhra Pradesh. As Mr. Neerabh Kumar Prasad is going to retire on 31st December 2024, a new one has to take over from January 2025 onwards. Actually, Mr. Neerabh Kumar Prasad was supposed to retire by 30th June 2024. The present Government has extended his service for six months. It is learned that there is no chance of extending his service again. So, he has to retire from his duties on 31st December 2024. Now, discussions are going on in the administrative circles about the new appointee.

As per seniority, there are three probables. One is Mr. Vijayanand, second is Mr. Sai Prasad, and the final one is Mr. RP Sisodia. As per the buzz, most of the chances are in favor of Mr. RP Sisodia. In the Alliance Government, there are three power centers, which nobody has ruled out. One is obviously Mr. N. Jamili Elections Only

in 2029, Not 2027

Amid growing speculation about the timing of joint elections, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has clarified that even if the Joint Election Bill is passed, Jamili (joint) elections will only be held in 2029, not 2027. This comes as the Central Cabinet has already approved the concept of Jamili elections, and the Jamili Election Bill is expected to be introduced in Parliament on Monday, with an anticipated approval soon after. Naidu, addressing concerns over the political discourse in the state, criticized YSRCP leaders for claiming that joint elections would occur as early as 2027. He accused them of not fully understanding the issue and using it to serve their own political interests. He pointed out that the public has grown increasingly distrustful of YSRCP leaders' statements, dismissing their remarks as merely a source of amusement for the people. Additionally, Naidu reiterated his party's support for the "One Nation, One Election" initiative, while stressing that the timeline for the joint elections remains set for 2029. He also emphasized the importance of promoting the "Swarna Andhra Vision 2047" document among the people, particularly in educational institutions, to foster a better understanding of the state's future development goals.

Naidu expressed confidence in the success of Vision 2047, drawing parallels with the achievements of Vision 2020, and urged that the youth take part in shaping a prosperous future. He announced upcoming changes to the Collector's Conference, where meetings will be more interactive, with an emphasis on questions and answers rather than lengthy deliberations. Future meeting agendas will be shared in advance with collectors and SPs, who will be expected to respond to key issues.

Minister Narayana Announces Long-Term Road Development Plan for Amaravati

With Seamless National Highway Connectivity

Minister Narayana announced that the construction of roads in Amaravati, the state capital, is being designed with a long-term vision, aiming to connect the city directly to national highways while ensuring minimal disruption to residents and private properties. The roads are being planned with a 30-year horizon, focusing on sustainable development and seamless connectivity.

The Minister emphasized that roads will connect Amaravati to National Highway No. 16, specifically through the extension of E11 and E13 roads. Designs for these roads have already been prepared by Lee Associates, and inspections were conducted in villages like Mangalagiri, Navuluru, and Errabalem to assess the field-level situation and routes for the new roads. The development will extend from the seed capital to national highways, significantly improving accessibility. While highlighting the importance of the project, Narayana assured



the public that efforts will be made to avoid significant damage to private properties. The government is taking precautions to minimize the impact, especially in areas where homes might be affected. He urged cooperation from those whose properties may be impacted, stating that officials and public representatives will discuss the matter with affected individuals and ensure fair compensation and justice.

Narayana also inspected the Vijayawada West Bypass, a key road project passing through Amaravati, and suggested improvements to the Na-



tional Highways Authority of India. The Minister confirmed that every kilometer of the West Bypass would be well-connected to roads within the capital.

The road development initiative is part of an extensive infrastructure plan that includes 16 roads running east to west and 18 running north to south, aiming to enhance the city's connectivity and promote smoother travel, with a targeted speed limit of 80 to 100 km per hour. The government is focused on building Amaravati into a well-connected, sustainable city for future generations.

MP Avinash Reddy has made sensational allegations against TDP leaders, accusing them of manipulating the irrigation society elections in Kadapa district. He specifically targeted Pulivendula TDP in-charge B.Tech Ravi, accusing him of orchestrating the entire process, likening his actions to writing a movie script. Avinash Reddy claimed that TDP leaders, in an effort to influence the elections, detained officials, including VROs, who were unavailable to issue no-due certificates at tehsildar offices. He expressed frustration over what he described as a campaign of false politics by the TDP, attacking the media and hindering the election process. "Is this how elections are going to be held? Are the officials going to be arrested and elections manipulated?" Reddy remarked.

He further criticized the TDP for making false promises to farmers during their time in power and claimed they were aware they would lose the irrigation society elections. According to Reddy, the TDP's actions were a desperate attempt to hold elections by any means, even if it meant arresting officials. He contrasted the situation with the previous YSRCP government's free and fair elections, suggesting that the current environment under TDP was anything but transparent.

The elections were held under tense circumstances, with clashes between YCP and TDP workers in various parts of Kadapa, including Pulivendula, Jammalamadugu, and Badvel.

Somireddy questioned whether Jagan was prepared to release a white paper on the performance of the agriculture department, as farmers continue to face mounting challenges. He asserted that the Swarnandhra Vision 2047 document, introduced by opposition leaders, places significant emphasis on agriculture and farmer welfare—a stark contrast to the current government's approach.

Criticizing Jagan's administration, Somireddy claimed that Andhra Pradesh now ranks first in farmer suicides, a tragic consequence of mismanagement and lack of support. He accused Jagan of dismantling key agricultural initiatives, such as micro-irrigation, nutrient subsidies, and other farmer incentives, leaving He demanded that the Chief Minister take accountfarmers in distress. "The extent of the agricultural decline under Jagan can be best explained by the farmers of Pulivendula themselves," he remarked, referring to Jagan's home constituency.

Highlighting further issues, Ramakrishna noted that Andhra Pradesh has yet to receive 3,000 MW of solar power as promised by October 2024. He criticized the decision to buy power from SECI at a high price of ₹2.49 per unit, compared to Gujarat, which procures it at ₹1.89 per unit.



Meanwhile, the High Court recently held a hearing on the contentious agreements. Fulfillment of Division Promises Key to Andhra Pradesh's Growth - YS Sharmila

APCC Chief YS Sharmila sharply criticized successive governments for failing to fulfill the promises made during the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh. Speaking to the media on Saturday, Sharmila stated that the state's path to becoming number one lies not in visions like Swarna Andhra Vision - 2047, but in the immediate realization of commitments made by the Center a decade ago.

Sharmila recalled that during the state's division, the Congress-led UPA government had promised special status to Andhra Pradesh, along with significant infrastructure and financial projects. However, she lamented that these promises have remained unfulfilled, leaving the state at a disadvantage.

Unmet Promises Under the Bifurcation Act Sharmila highlighted key projects included in the Andhra Pradesh Reorganization Act that have stalled:

- Polavaram Project: Promised national status but still incomplete.
- Kadapa Steel Plant & Duggarajupatnam Port: Yet to materialize.
- Infrastructure Development: Visakhapatnam-Chennai Industrial Corridor, petroleum university, new railway zone, and metro rail projects in Vijayawada and Visakhapatnam remain dreams.
- Special Financial Package: Aimed at backward districts, but never implemented.
- She argued that if these projects were completed, Andhra Pradesh would have seen significant industrial growth, job creation, and urban development.

Sharmila accused Prime Minister Narendra Modi, TDP leader Chandrababu Naidu, and CM YS Jagan Mohan Reddy of betraying the state. She claimed Modi failed to deliver on his promises, while Chandrababu misled the people with false assurances about lifetime special



status. Jagan, she added, has failed to hold the Center accountable, despite his earlier claims of leveraging 25 MPs for Andhra Pradesh's benefit.

Sharmila called for immediate action, stating that the only path to Andhra Pradesh's development is the grant of special status. She demanded that Chandrababu and Jagan pressure the Prime Minister to fulfill the division promises, asserting, "Special status is the vision for Andhra Pradesh's future.'

Sharmila concluded by urging the people to hold the leaders accountable and push for the implementation of the long-overdue commitments, which she described as critical to changing the state's direction and prosperity.

YCP to Boycott Irrigation Society Elections – Botsa

CM Chandrababu Received Petitions From People at TDP Central Office Victims Seek Justice from CM

TPN Correspondent Mangalagiri, Dec 15 At the TDP central office, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu received numerous petitions on Saturday, shedding light on injustices faced by the public during the previous YSRCP government. Complaints ranged from person-

al tragedies and land disputes to withheld pensions, showcasing the extent of grievances under the former administration.

Nishankara Shankarleela, from Gujjanagulla in Guntur district, tearfully recounted the tragic murder of her daughter, a final-year degree student, who went missing on July 4, 2022. She alleged that Anand, an auto driver, along with his brothers and relatives, tortured her daughter for 14 months, ultimately killing her. Despite her family's two-year-long fight for justice, they have faced harassment, including false cases filed against them. The accused reportedly claimed connections to former minister Vidadala Rajani and MLC Lella Appireddy.

Shankarleela alleged that even the police turned against them, with a former Nallapadu CI using abusive language instead of addressing their grievances. Fake Currency Racket Busted in Srikakulam, YCP Leader Among Accused

TPN Correspondent, Srikakulam: Srikakulam police have uncovered a massive fake currency racket with the arrest of two gangs involved in printing and circulating counterfeit notes. This crackdown has created a stir, especially with the involvement of a political leader. DSP Tekkali Murthy and CI Avtaram revealed that fake notes worth approximately ₹50,000 were initially seized from Tammireddy Ravi, a resident of Santalakshmipuram village in Meliyaputti mandal, near the Andhra-Odisha border. Based on information provided by him, police arrested five others, including Kusi Reddy Durvasulu (Shankar Reddy), Tammireddy Delhi Rao, Dasari Kumaraswamy, Dasari Ravikumar, and Dummu Dharma Rao, from Palasa, Meliyaputti, and Vajrakotturu mandals.

During the operation, authorities seized fake notes amounting to ₹57.25 lakh, along with



a color printer, four mobile phones, and a scooter used in the production and transportation of counterfeit currency. The involvement of Dasari Ravikumar, a YCP MPTC member from Karajada, has added a political dimension to the case and heightened public interest.

In a parallel operation, the police arrested two other suspects, Ganagalla Ravi from Kothadibpalapaleni in Etcherla mandal and Rajesh from Laver, while they were attempting to circulate ₹15 lakh worth of counterfeit notes in Salur in Vizianagaram district and parts of Odisha. Investigations revealed that the duo sourced fake notes from Parlakhemundi and Gunupuram in Odisha. They were also found to have collaborated with Rapaka Prabhakar alias Pratap Reddy and Krishnamurthy, who are currently absconding. Ravi and Rajesh had reportedly procured chemicals for manufacturing the notes from Bhadrachalam.

The police are continuing their efforts to apprehend other suspects and have assured stringent action against those involved. This operation has raised alarms about the growing menace of fake currency in the region and its potential links to larger criminal networks.

Gukesh's Historic Chess Victory: A New Era of Indian Supremacy

Gukesh Dommaraju, at the age of 18 years, 6 months, and 14 days, has stunned the world by becoming the youngest-ever World Chess Champion. On December 12, 2024, the teenage chess prodigy from India triumphed over defending champion Ding Liren of China in a thrilling final game that lasted over five hours. The 14-game series culminated in a dramatic endgame, which, despite expectations of a draw, saw Gukesh emerge victorious, showcasing his exceptional skill and composure.

Gukesh's victory marks a historic moment for both India and the world of chess. He became the 51st World Chess Champion and the 18th individual to achieve this prestigious title, joining the ranks of legends in chess history. His win also signifies a remarkable milestone in Indian chess, as it continues to dominate the global stage, following the success of Vishwanathan Anand, India's first World Chess Champion. Anand, who has been a mentor to Gukesh, expressed immense pride in his student's achievement, calling it a moment of great significance for Indian chess.

India's Agricultural Policy: A Price Check is Needed

India's agricultural policy has long focused on expanding markets and integrating technology into the sector. While these efforts are commendable, they often overlook the crucial issue of fair farmgate prices for farmers. Without addressing existing logistical bottlenecks and the dominance of buyers in the market, the policy risks being ineffective in improving the economic conditions of farmers.

The Draft National Policy Framework on Agricultural Marketing, introduced by the Government of India, aims to tackle structural inefficiencies in agricultural marketing and enhance farmers' incomes. It identifies key problems, such as fragmented markets, poor infrastructure, and the lack of digital integration. However, these solutions often fail to address the most pressing issues farmers face — price volatility, supply-demand imbalances, and buyer cartelization.

Farmers' incomes are largely driven by the prices they receive for their produce. Unfortunately, these prices remain volatile, often subject to price crashes, and distortions caused by supply chain inefficiencies. Cartelized buyer behavior further exacerbates this issue, as middlemen and large corporate buyers can suppress prices, leaving farmers with minimal earnings. In such a scenario, technological advancements or market expansion become moot if farmers cannot sell their products at a fair price.

The framework does acknowledge important agricultural achievements, such as record food grain production and increased exports. It also recognizes challenges like fragmented landholdings and limited market access. However, it does not go far enough in addressing the core issue of low farmer incomes, which is primarily a result of price fluctuations and inadequate market access. While the policy addresses structural barriers such as high production costs and inefficient supply chains, it falls short of providing clear and actionable solutions to ensure fair price realization for farmers.

The framework envisions a vibrant, competitive, and transparent marketing ecosystem, emphasizing the adoption of innovative technologies and value chain-centric marketing. However, the focus on competition and transparency fails to address the ongoing power imbalance between farmers and buyers. Cartels often exploit the lack of transparency, preventing farmers from receiving their fair share of the value they generate.

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy recently made waves with his remarks about movie stars, saying, "I am the star; I should have my own fan following. Why should I be someone else's fan?" He was responding to a question about his favorite movie stars during an interview. Known for his sharp political acumen and smart appearance, Reddy has worked to restore the Congress party's prominence in Telangana. However, his recent comments, especially regarding the arrest of Telugu cinema star Allu Arjun, have raised eyebrows.

Reddy showed little sympathy for the film industry and its business practices when discussing the stampede that led to the death of a 39-yearold woman and the injury of her son at a movie event attended by Allu Arjun. The Chief Minister dismissed the role of entertainment figures in such incidents, stating that they merely "invest money, earn profits, and go home."

However, the main issue at hand is whether Reddy, who also serves as the Home Minister, followed due process when the police arrested Allu Arjun. Reports suggest that the actor was detained in a manner that lacked basic decency, with police reportedly entering his bedroom and



taking him to the station without allowing him time to change clothes or speak to his family. Despite securing bail, Allu Arjun spent the night in jail.

The bigger question is whether there was enough evidence to charge the actor with culpable homicide not amounting to murder, as suggested by Reddy. The Chief Minister argued that Allu Ar-

jun's actions, such as standing on his car and waving to the crowd, were enough to implicate him. However, this view overlooks the common practice in the film industry of engaging with fans to promote movies.

Further complicating matters, a letter from the theatre management requesting additional security for the event on December 4, well before

the incident, seems to suggest that the police were aware of the crowd's size and the presence of film stars. This raises the question: should the police have done more to coordinate with the theatre and prevent the tragedy? Reddy's decision to proceed with the arrest, despite his personal connection to the actor, also raises concerns about political influence and selective accountability in such matters.





Congress Can Never Erase Taint Of Emergency: PM On Constitution Debate

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched a scathing attack on the Congress party during a debate on the Constitution in Parliament, accusing the party of imposing Emergency to preserve political power. "Even Indira Gandhi's election was declared void, yet she invoked Emergency in rage to save her seat, misusing the Constitution for personal gain," he said. Modi further criti-



cized her leadership, highlighting the or political advantage. "Nehru ji started thousands of people imprisoned during this period and the government's lack of empathy toward the suffering public.

Modi also condemned the actions of Indira Gandhi's son, Rajiv Gandhi, accusing him of overturning the Supreme Court's Shah Bano verdict in favor of a vote bank. He claimed that the Congress party's political dynasty continued a legacy of disregarding justice for personal

Savarkar's criticism of the Indian Constitution to accuse the ruling party of defaming its own values. Gandhi referenced Savarkar's assertion that there was "nothing Indian about the Constitution," and alleged that the BJP is undermining the very foundation of the nation by claiming to protect it.

Gandhi further criticized the BJP and its ideological ally, the RSS, calling them "supporters of Manusmriti," an ancient text considered to promote caste-based discrimination. In contrast, he emphasized that the country is governed by the Constitution, which guarantees rights and justice for all.

Drawing a parallel with the mythological story of Eklavya, Gandhi argued that the BJP government is metaphorically "chopping off the thumb" of various sections of society. In a candid interview, Abdullah called on the Centre to fulfill its promise and restore statehood to Jammu and Kashmir at the earliest, emphasizing that a unified administrative structure is essential for the region's progress.

This marks Abdullah's first in-depth interview since taking office in October, and he voiced cautious optimism regarding the Centre's commitment to restoring the region's statehood. He referred to repeated assurances made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah during election campaigns, signaling hope that the promises would soon be honored.

Abdullah's comments reflect the political complexities in Jammu and Kashmir since its special status was revoked in 2019. His remarks point to the challenges of governing under the current system, where the region is run by both a local chief minister and a centrally appointed lieutenant governor, leading to divided authority.

The chief minister likened the situation to corporate leadership, arguing that organizations do not thrive under multiple leaders. "Having two power centres anywhere is a recipe for disaster," Abdullah said, stressing that no successful entity operates without a clear, unified leadership structure. He further emphasized that even in sports, teams do not function effectively under two captains, highlighting the need for clarity and consistency in leadership.

By calling for the restoration of statehood, Abdullah is pushing for a return to a more defined administrative framework for Jammu and Kashmir, which would empower the elected government and provide a singular focus for governance. His stance challenges the current system, advocating for greater autonomy and a return to the status quo that existed before the revocation of Article 370.





South Korea President Yoon Impeached, PM **Han Duck-so Becomes Interim President**

SEOUL: South Korea's President Yoon Suk Yeol has been impeached following his attempt to impose martial law, leading to his suspension from presidential duties. Prime Minister Han Duck-so has stepped in as the acting president in line with the constitution, taking on the crucial task of managing the country through its most significant political crisis in decades.

Han, 75, is a career technocrat with a distinguished background, which includes decades of service in key governmental roles under five different presidents, both conservative and liberal. Known for his rationality and experience in diplomacy, economics, and governance, Han's moderate demeanor has earned him respect across political factions. His tenure as acting president will be critical, especially with South Korea facing threats from its nuclear-armed neighbor North Korea and a sluggish domestic economy.

Having served as prime minister since Yoon's administration began in 2022, Han is familiar with the role, having also held the position under former President Roh Moo-hyun in 2007-2008. His reputation for competence has led him to high-profile positions, including ambassador to the United States and finance minister. Fluent in English, Han's work on the U.S.-South Korea Free Trade Agreement further cemented his standing in international relations.



18000 Indians Face Deportation Risk As **Trump Vows Immigration Crackdown**

WASHINGTON: As US President-elect Donald Trump prepares to take office, stricter immigration policies are already taking shape, with significant implications for undocumented immigrants. The US Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has compiled a list of 1.45 million people slated for deportation, which includes approximately 18,000 undocumented Indians.

In the past three years, around 90,000 Indians have been apprehended attempting to illegally cross the US border, with most coming from states like Punjab, Gujarat, and Andhra Pradesh, according to the Times of India. For many of these undocumented individuals, the path to legalizing their status is fraught with bureaucratic hurdles, with waiting periods often extending two to three years.

While India is not the country with the India has been classified as one of the highest number of undocumented immigrants in the US, it ranks 13th in Asia, with 17,940 individuals on the list. Countries bordering the US, such as Honduras and Guatemala, have the highest number of undocumented immigrants, with 261,000 and 253,000 individuals respectively. In Asia, China leads with 37,908 undocu-



mented individuals.

Blinken meets Iraq PM discuss Syria, vows to fight against ISIS

Sri Lanka Supports Adani **Group's Self-Funding for Colombo Port Project**

Cri Lanka's govern-**J**ment has expressed its support for the Adani-led conglomerate's decision to use its own resources to fund the ongoing deep-water container terminal project at the Colombo port. Ports Minister Bimal Rathnayaka emphasized that the government is eager to see the successful completion of the project, which is critical for the country's revenue generation.

In a recent statement, Rathnayaka confirmed that the Sri Lankan government had no objections to the Adani Group's decision to fund the Colombo West International Terminal (CWIT) project through its own internal accruals. This move follows a previous agreement by the US International Development Finance Corporation (DFC) to provide a USD 553 million loan to support the development and construction of the terminal. However, Adani Ports and SEZ Ltd announced in a filing on Tuesday that it would now proceed with the project using its own financial resources, aligning with its broader capital management strategy.

The CWIT project, part of the ongoing development of the Port of Colombo, is seen as a vital infrastructure project for Sri Lanka, with significant implications for the coun-



try's trade and economic growth. Rathnayaka highlighted the importance of the terminal, noting that it would contribute to both the port's revenue and the broader economy.

While the US-based DFC's funding was initially part of the plan, the Adani Group's decision to withdraw from the arrangement and fund the project independently has been described as an internal business decision. The Sri Lankan government, however, remains fully supportive, underscoring that the project's completion is a priority.

With the project scheduled for commissioning by early next year, the Adani-led initiative is expected to enhance the port's capacity, boosting Sri Lanka's position as a key player in global maritime trade.

India's Economic Recovery Expected in FY25, with Positive Outlook for Equity Markets

India's economic growth is expect-ed to rebound in the second half of FY25, driven by a recovery in government capital expenditure post-elections, rural consumption recovery, and strong festive season demand, according to a report by Motilal Oswal Private Wealth (MOPW). The report, titled the Alpha Strategist Report, highlights that India is poised to maintain its position as one of the fastest-growing major economies globally, characterized by stable growth and relatively low volatility.

The report notes that the Indian economy continues to show resilience, positioning the country for gradual growth as it recovers from

the recent slowdown. It also points out that the equity markets are currently in a consolidation phase, following a 10-12% correction in the benchmark indices. Despite the correction, the report indicates that large-cap valuations now appear attractive for investors.

In light of the market's recent performance, the report recommends that investors adopt a balanced strategy, considering lump-sum investments in Hybrid, Large, and Flexi-cap funds. For mid- and small-cap strategies, the report suggests a more staggered approach over three months to mitigate risks and capitalize on potential market rebounds.

The report also highlights the recent return of foreign institutional investors (FII) to the Indian markets, with a net infusion of Rs 9,947 crore after 38



sessions of net selling. This indicates growing investor confidence in India's economic recovery and prospects.

While maintaining a positive long-term outlook for the equity markets, the report advises caution, recommending that investors align their strategies based on their risk profiles. It suggests increasing equity allocation if it is lower than desired levels, using a lump-sum investment strategy for largecap and hybrid strategies and a phased approach for mid- and small-cap funds.

Regarding fixed income investments, the report suggests an overweight position in accrual strategies and a neutral stance on duration-based strategies, considering the evolving interest rate environment.

India's Export Growth to the US: A **30-Year Success Story**

Tndia's exports to the United States Lhave seen steady growth, reaching USD 77.5 billion in FY24, reflecting a compounded annual growth rate (CAGR) of 10.3% over the past 30 years, according to a report by Bank of Baroda. This increase highlights the growing importance of the US as a destination for Indian goods.

SEBI to Review Algo Trading Rules to Boost Retail Participation

On Friday, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) announced plans to review the existing regulatory framework for algorithmic trading (algo trading) in order to enhance the participation of retail investors. The move comes as part of SEBI's efforts to modernize the market structure and encourage wider engagement in the stock markets.

Algorithmic trading, or algo trading, involves the use of automated execution logic to generate and place orders in the financial markets. These trades are executed at high speed and with precise timing, which can provide significant advantages, such as improved efficiency and reduced costs. By automating the trading process, algo trading eliminates the need for manual intervention, allowing for quicker and more accurate order execution.

The proposed review of the algo trading framework aims to make it more accessible to retail investors, who have traditionally been at a disadvantage compared to institutional traders that use advanced



technologies for high-frequency trading. SEBI's initiative seeks to level the playing field by introducing measures that will allow retail participants to benefit from the same technological advantages, thus increasing their market participation.

Currently, the regulatory environment for algorithmic trading is primarily tailored to institutional traders, with stringent requirements regarding infrastructure, risk management, and compliance. SEBI's review will focus on identifying potential changes to the rules that could encourage retail investors to adopt algorithmic strategies, while ensuring that safeguards are in place to prevent market disruptions and ensure investor protection.

The move is expected to create new opportunities for retail investors, empowering them to leverage the power of algorithms for better trade execution and portfolio management. It also aligns with SEBI's broader objective of enhancing market efficiency and fostering a more inclusive trading ecosystem.

With the increasing role of technology in the financial markets, SEBI's review of the algo trading framework signals a forward-looking approach to adapt to the evolving trading landscape.


