

ANOTHER MEGA DSC WITH 6,000 POSTS SOON: **BHATTI VIKRAMARKA**

TPN Correspondent, Khammam : Telangana Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka announced plans for another mega DSC recruitment drive, offering 6,000 posts. Speaking during a one-day statewide hostel inspection program, Bhatti visited welfare and Gurukul schools in Khammam, Madhira, and Bonakal.

During the visit, Bhatti officially launched a new menu for all welfare hostels across the state. Addressing the media, he highlighted the financial difficulties students faced due to stagnant mess and cosmetic charges, which had not been revised in 10 and 16 years, respectively.

"In our tenure, we increased diet charges by 40 percent and cosmetic charges by 200 percent to reflect rising costs. We are committed to resolving students' issues and supporting the unemployed by soon releasing a mega DSC notification with 6,000 posts," he stated.

The initiative is expected to benefit both students in welfare hostels and job aspirants awaiting government recruitment.

ED ISSUES NOTICES TO FORMER BRS MLA MARRI JANARDHAN REDDY

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has intensified its investigation into the 50acre land registration case involving IAS officer Amoy Kumar, accusing him of privatizing land worth over Rs. 1000 crores in Hyderabad's suburbs. Notices have been issued to former BRS MLA Marri Janardhan Reddy, Vamsi Ram Builders chief Subba Reddy, and two other individuals to appear for questioning on December 16.

The case revolves around the illegal registration of land in Nagaram, Maheshwaram mandal, with the ED linking Reddy and others to the pri-



TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad: Telangana's Health Minister C. Damodar Raja Narasimha on Saturday, December 13, reassured contract Auxiliary Nurse Midwives (ANMs) about their job security after the appointment of regular staff. He also confirmed that the scheduled written examination for regular ANM positions will take place as planned on December 29.

The Minister held a detailed discussion with contract ANMs regarding their concerns over job regularization. Narasimha clarified that the issue is currently under judicial review but affirmed that the recruitment examination would



proceed without any changes.

Additionally, he announced that 30 marks would continue to be awarded as weightage for contract ANMs in the re-

cruitment process, encouraging them to prepare for the exam.

In response to demands for more positions, the Minister confirmed that 323 additional vacancies would be added to the previously announced 1,931 posts, increasing the total number of available positions to 2,254.

Narasimha assured the contract ANMs that those who do not secure regular positions would continue their contract roles until the end of their term. Regarding retirement benefits, the Minister stated that a decision would be made after further discussions with the Chief Minister.

Govt Forms Committee for University Recruitment Overhaul

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : On Friday, December 13, the One of the main challenges discussed during the meeting Telangana government set up a three-member committee to review and streamline recruitment procedures for university faculty. This move follows a meeting convened by the Telangana Council of Higher Education (TGCHE) with vice-chancellors from various state universities.

The committee, which will be chaired by Ghanta Chakrapani, former chairman of the Telangana Public Service Commission and ex-vice chancellor of Dr. BR Ambedkar Open University, aims to develop optimized recruitment models for teaching staff. The focus will be on aligning these practices with University Grants Commission (UGC) regulations and the government's directives outlined in GO Ms No 15.

In addition to Chakrapani, the committee will include LAD) funds to support university budgets. vice-chancellors from Osmania University and Mahatma Gandhi University, as well as two additional experts. The committee will explore various recruitment models used in other states, such as Bihar's practice of hiring faculty through the Public Service Commission (PSC). The committee will then provide recommendations on best practices for Telangana.

was faculty recruitment. TGCHE Chairman V. Balakista Reddy highlighted the need to address this issue efficiently. The committee will also investigate superannuation policies and career advancement schemes (CAS) for faculty members to ensure transparency, fairness, and efficiency.



As part of the broader education reform efforts, the TGCHE plans to review university affiliation processes, develop strategies to improve institutional rankings, and align universities with national and international educational standards. In addition, vice-chancellors were encouraged to diversify funding sources through corporate social responsibility (CSR) initiatives and Members of Parliament Local Area Development (MP-

The TGCHE also plans to update outdated course syllabi to better equip students for the global job market, and address concerns raised by vice-chancellors on infrastructure, scholarships, and other university issues.

vatization scheme. Investigations have revealed that Amoy Kumar allegedly converted Bhoodan lands into private patta lands, a process that led to the illegal registration of properties worth hundreds of crores.

The ED's probe was initially triggered by a complaint filed by a person named Dastagiri, and after the police registered a case, it has now been handed over to the ED for further investigation. Authorities have identified that Janardhan Reddy, Subba Reddy, K. Siddha Reddy of KSR Mines, and Suryateja of Ammada Developers benefitted from the alleged illegal activity.

INTER EXAM SCHEDULE FINALIZED IN TELANGANA



TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : The Telangana government has finalized the schedule for the upcoming Inter exams, with official sources confirming that the schedule is almost ready for release. It is expected that the schedule will be officially announced next week. According to reports, the Inter exams are set to begin on March 3 and will conclude by the end of the month, with exams spanning 15 to 20 days across various Inter groups.

The practical exams are scheduled to be completed in February, ahead of the main exams. Officials emphasized that the exams must start on March 3 to ensure completion within the month.

The fee deadline for the Inter exams ended on December 3, but the Inter Board has extended the payment option until January 2 with a late fee of Rs. 2,000. Approximately 9 to 10 lakh students across Telangana are expected to appear for the exams, and arrangements are being made accordingly to accommodate them.





Rs 24 Lakh Stolen from SBI ATM in Nalgonda, Investigation Underway

TPN Correspondent, Nalgonda: - A significant theft occurred at a State Bank of India (SBI) ATM in Nalgonda district, Telangana, on Friday, December 13, with criminals making away with Rs. 24 lakh. The incident has raised concerns as a notorious gang is suspected to be behind the theft. Nalgonda Superintendent of Police, Sarath Chandra Pawar, visited the crime scene and is leading the investigation. Special teams have been formed to track down the culprits, and police have increased security in the area.

Authorities have urged local residents to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities to assist in the ongoing investigation. The theft comes shortly after an attempted break-in at an ATM in Nirmal district earlier in November.



Fire Accident Destroys Rs 2 Crore Worth of Cotton in Telangana



TPN Correspondent, Aler: A devastating fire at Mallikarjuna Cotton Mill in Aler mandal, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district, has caused significant damage, destroying cotton worth over Rs. 2 crore. The fire, which broke out on Saturday afternoon, led to the destruction of around 3,000 quintals of cotton. Thankfully, no casualties have been reported.

Local sources indicated that the fire rapidly engulfed a large portion of the cotton stock, sending thick black smoke and flames visible from several nearby villages, creating widespread panic. Firefighters from various stations have been working tirelessly to control the blaze and prevent further destruction.

Preliminary investigations suggest the fire could have been caused by an electrical short circuit, although the exact cause is still being determined. Local authorities are working to assess the full extent of the damage, while efforts to extinguish the fire continue.

CM REVANTH REDDY'S KEY COMMENTS ON SC CLASSIFICATION

He criticized the delay in paying salaries, noting that even by the 14th day of the month, Anganwadi teachers and nurses have yet to receive their dues.

Harish Rao slammed the government for its earlier claims of paying employee salaries on the first day of the month. "It's a farce. Salaries haven't been paid on time, and Anganwadi center rents have been pending for ten months," he said.

The MLA expressed concern over the hardships faced by retired employees, who are reportedly being denied their rightful retirement benefits except when mandated by High Court orders. "This government is causing untold distress to employees and their families," he remarked.



Harish Rao highlighted that Anganwadi teachers, ayas, retired teachers, contract workers, and outsourcing employees are all struggling due to delayed salaries. He urged the government to end its misleading claims about timely salary payments and take immediate steps to address these issues.

ALLU ARJUN'S ARREST UNFORTUNATE, COURT'S BAIL A RELIEF

LAW WILL TAKE ITS COURSE TPCC CHIEF MAHESH KUMAR **GOUD ON ALLU ARJUN CASE**



TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad: Telangana PCC president Mahesh Kumar Goud clarified there is no bias against actor Allu Arjun but questioned, "Should we not take action if a poor woman dies in a stampede?" Addressing the media, Goud emphasized that the Congress party holds no grudge against any film actor and affirmed that the law is being followed in Allu Arjun's case.

"Even though the tragedy was unexpected, a case was filed as per the law, he was arrested, and bail was later granted by the court. The law will take its course," Goud stated.

He condemned BJP leaders' attempts to politicize the issue, accusing them of blaming the Congress-led government unfairly. Goud also highlighted the Congress party's historical support for the film industry, pointing out that Congress chief ministers were instrumental in relocating the film industry from Chennai to Hyderabad.

"The Congress party respects the film industry and has no animosity toward any actor. Cases involving film stars are handled purely within the ambit of the law," he said. Goud urged BJP leaders to refrain from making baseless allegations against the Congress government.

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : Congress leader and Khairatabad MLA Danam Nagender expressed his disappointment over the arrest of film actor Allu Arjun, stating it caused him emotional distress. He also emphasized his personal admiration for the actor, adding that Allu Arjun holds a special place in the hearts of Telugu people and has significantly elevated the Telugu film industry's stature on international platforms.Nagender concluded by reiterating his regret over the incident and voiced hope that such situations would not arise in the future.

ALLU ARJUN'S CONSPIRACY AGAINST JOHNNY MASTER, SUFFERED THE CONSEQUENCES

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : The arrest of Icon Star Allu Arjun has sparked widespread discussions not just in the Telugu states, but across the country. The incident occurred during the Pushpa to Benefit show at Sandhya Theater, where a stampede tragically led to the death of a woman named Revathi, and her son was seriously injured and is currently undergoing treatment in the hospital. In connection with this, the Chikkadapalli police have filed cases against Allu Arjun, leading to his arrest. He was later produced in court, remanded for 14 days, but granted interim bail by the Telangana High Court, allowing him to be released from Chanchalguda jail early this morning.

The incident has triggered varying opinions across Telangana. Some are supporting the government's actions, while others are criticizing the arrest, claiming it was unfair and biased. Congress

Mallanna, who previously questioned Johnny Master's message to society regarding red sandalwood theft, drew a parallel to Allu Arjun, remarking that the actor's night in jail was the consequence of the actions portrayed in Pushpa.

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad : Lawyers representing actor Allu Arjun are planning to take legal action over the delay in his release, despite the Telangana High Court's clear order for his immediate release in connection with the Sandhya Theater stampede incident.Ashok Reddy, Bunny's lawyer, addressed the media after his release from Chanchalguda Jail on Saturday morning. He stated that although the jail authorities had received a copy of the bail order from the High Court, they kept the actor in detention unlawfully. According to Reddy, the High Court's order explicitly stated that Allu Arjun should be released immediately upon receipt of the order.

"The authorities did not comply with the High Court's order and kept him in illegal detention. We will take legal action against this unlawful delay," said lawyer Ashok Reddy.While Bunny's legal team insisted there was no delay in submitting the bail order to the jail authorities, the jail officials claimed that they received the bail order late in the night. According to the jail manual, prisoners cannot be released during the night, which led to his release being delayed until 6:40 AM the next day. Allu Arjun had been granted four weeks of interim bail by the Telangana High Court. After being released, the actor went to his family's production house, Geetha Arts, where he met with his lawyers for a discussion.

Gukesh's Historic Chess Victory: A New Era of Indian Supremacy

Gukesh Dommaraju, at the age of 18 years, 6 months, and 14 days, has stunned the world by becoming the youngest-ever World Chess Champion. On December 12, 2024, the teenage chess prodigy from India triumphed over defending champion Ding Liren of China in a thrilling final game that lasted over five hours. The 14-game series culminated in a dramatic endgame, which, despite expectations of a draw, saw Gukesh emerge victorious, showcasing his exceptional skill and composure.

India's Agricultural Policy: A Price Check is Needed

India's agricultural policy has long focused on expanding markets and integrating technology into the sector. While these efforts are commendable, they often overlook the crucial issue of fair farmgate prices for farmers. Without addressing existing logistical bottlenecks and the dominance of buyers in the market, the policy risks being ineffective in improving the economic conditions of farmers.

The Draft National Policy Framework on Agricultural Marketing, introduced by the Government of India, aims to tackle structural inefficiencies in agricultural marketing and enhance farmers' incomes. It identifies key problems, such as fragmented markets, poor infrastructure, and the lack of digital integration. However, these solutions often fail to address the most pressing issues farmers face — price volatility, supply-demand imbalances, and buyer cartelization.

Farmers' incomes are largely driven by the prices they receive for their produce. Unfortunately, these prices remain volatile, often subject to price crashes, and distortions caused by supply chain inefficiencies. Cartelized buyer behavior further exacerbates this issue, as middlemen and large corporate buyers can suppress prices, leaving farmers with minimal earnings. In such a scenario, technological advancements or market expansion become moot if farmers cannot sell their products at a fair price.

The framework does acknowledge important agricultural achievements, such as record food grain production and increased exports. It also recognizes challenges like fragmented landholdings and limited market access. However, it does not go far enough in addressing the core issue of low farmer incomes, which is primarily a result of price fluctuations and inadequate market access. While the policy addresses structural barriers such as high production costs and inefficient supply chains, it falls short of providing clear and actionable solutions to ensure fair price realization for farmers.

The framework envisions a vibrant, competitive, and transparent marketing ecosystem, emphasizing the adoption of innovative technologies and value chain-centric marketing. However, the focus on competition and transparency fails to address the ongoing power imbalance between farmers and buyers. Cartels often exploit the lack of transparency, preventing farmers from receiving their fair share of the value they generate.

It must ensure that farmers are paid fairly for their hard work, addressing the market's structural inefficiencies and the dominance of exploitative buyer cartels. Until these issues are resolved, farmers' incomes will continue to remain volatile, hindering the growth and sustainability of India's agricultural sector.

Layers Surrounding Allu Arjun's Arrest: Revanth **Reddy's Handling of Arjun Arrest Sparks Controversy**

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy recently made waves with his remarks about movie stars, saying, "I am the star; I should have my own fan following. Why should I be someone else's fan?" He was responding to a question about his favorite movie stars during an interview. Known for his sharp political acumen and smart appearance, Reddy has worked to restore the Congress party's prominence in Telangana. However, his recent comments, especially regarding the arrest of Telugu cinema star Allu Arjun, have raised eyebrows.

Reddy showed little sympathy for the film industry and its business practices when discussing the stampede that led to the death of a 39-yearold woman and the injury of her son at a movie event attended by Allu Arjun. The Chief Minister dismissed the role of entertainment figures in such incidents, stating that they merely "invest money, earn profits, and go home."

However, the main issue at hand is whether Reddy, who also serves as the Home Minister, followed due process when the police arrested Allu Arjun. Reports suggest that the actor was detained in a manner that lacked basic decency, with police reportedly entering his bedroom and



taking him to the station without allowing him time to change clothes or speak to his family. Despite securing bail, Allu Arjun spent the night in jail.

The bigger question is whether there was enough evidence to charge the actor with culpable homicide not amounting to murder, as suggested by Reddy. The Chief Minister argued that Allu Ar-

jun's actions, such as standing on his car and waving to the crowd, were enough to implicate him. However, this view overlooks the common practice in the film industry of engaging with fans to promote movies.

Further complicating matters, a letter from the theatre management requesting additional security for the event on December 4, well before

the incident, seems to suggest that the police were aware of the crowd's size and the presence of film stars. This raises the question: should the police have done more to coordinate with the theatre and prevent the tragedy? Reddy's decision to proceed with the arrest, despite his personal connection to the actor, also raises concerns about political influence and selective accountability in such matters.





Congress Can Never Erase Taint Of Emergency: PM On Constitution Debate

Country Will Be Run By Constitution, Not Manusmriti: Rahul targets BJP

Leader of Opposition Rahul Gandhi on Saturday launched a scathing attack on the BJP, citing Hindutva ideologue V.D. Savarkar's criticism of the Indian Constitution to accuse the ruling party of defaming its own values. Gandhi referenced Savarkar's assertion that there was "nothing Indian about the Constitution," and alleged that the BJP is undermining the very foundation of the nation by claiming to protect it.

Gandhi further criticized the BJP and its ideological ally, the RSS, calling them "supporters of Manusmriti," an ancient text considered to promote caste-based discrimination. In contrast, he emphasized that the country is governed by the Constitution, which guarantees rights and justice for all.

Drawing a parallel with the mythological story of Eklavya, Gandhi argued that the BJP government is metaphorically "chopping off the thumb" of various sections of society. He referred to the creation of monopolies by the Adani Group, the introduction of the Agnipath scheme, the violent crackdown on protesting farmers, and the introduction of lateral entry and paper leaks as examples of how the government is harming the livelihoods of youth, farmers, backward classes, and the poor.

Omar Abdullah Criticizes Dual Governance in J&K, Urges **Statehood Restoration**

Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah has sharply criticized the dual governance model in the Union Territory, where he shares power with the lieutenant governor, calling it a "recipe for disaster." In a candid interview, Abdullah called on the Centre to fulfill its promise and restore statehood to Jammu and Kashmir at the earliest, emphasizing that a unified administrative structure is essential for the region's progress.

This marks Abdullah's first in-depth interview since taking office in October, and he voiced cautious optimism regarding the Centre's commitment to restoring the region's statehood. He referred to repeated assurances made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah during election campaigns, signaling hope that the promises would soon be honored.

Abdullah's comments reflect the political complexities in Jammu and Kashmir since its special status was revoked in 2019. His remarks point to the challenges of governing under the current system, where the region is run by both a local chief minister and a centrally appointed lieutenant governor, leading to divided authority.

The chief minister likened the situation to corporate leadership, arguing that organizations do not thrive under multiple leaders. "Having two power centres anywhere is a recipe for disaster," Abdullah said, stressing that no successful entity operates without a clear, unified leadership structure. He further emphasized that even in sports, teams do not function effectively under two captains, highlighting the need for clarity and consistency in leadership.

By calling for the restoration of statehood, Abdullah is pushing for a return to a more defined administrative framework for Jammu and Kashmir, which would empower the elected government and provide a singular focus for governance. His stance challenges the current system, advocating for greater autonomy and a return to the status quo that existed before the revocation of Article 370.





South Korea President Yoon Impeached, PM **Han Duck-so Becomes Interim President**

SEOUL: South Korea's President Yoon Suk Yeol has been impeached following his attempt to impose martial law, leading to his suspension from presidential duties. Prime Minister Han Duck-so has stepped in as the acting president in line with the constitution, taking on the crucial task of managing the country through its most significant political crisis in decades.

Han, 75, is a career technocrat with a distinguished background, which includes decades of service in key governmental roles under five different presidents, both conservative and liberal. Known for his rationality and experience in diplomacy, economics, and governance, Han's moderate demeanor has earned him respect across political factions. His tenure as acting president will be critical, especially with South Korea facing threats from its nuclear-armed neighbor North Korea and a sluggish domestic economy.

Having served as prime minister since Yoon's administration began in 2022, Han is familiar with the role, having also held the position under former President Roh Moo-hyun in 2007-2008. His reputation for competence has led him to high-profile positions, including ambassador to the United States and finance minister. Fluent in English, Han's work on the U.S.-South Korea Free Trade Agreement further cemented his standing in international relations.



18000 Indians Face Deportation Risk As **Trump Vows Immigration Crackdown**

WASHINGTON: As US President-elect Donald Trump prepares to take office, stricter immigration policies are already taking shape, with significant implications for undocumented immigrants. The US Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) has compiled a list of 1.45 million people slated for deportation, which includes approximately 18,000 undocumented Indians.

In the past three years, around 90,000 Indians have been apprehended attempting to illegally cross the US border, with most coming from states like Punjab, Gujarat, and Andhra Pradesh, according to the Times of India. For many of these undocumented individuals, the path to legalizing their status is fraught with bureaucratic hurdles, with waiting periods often extending two to three years.

While India is not the country with the India has been classified as one of the highest number of undocumented immigrants in the US, it ranks 13th in Asia, with 17,940 individuals on the list. Countries bordering the US, such as Honduras and Guatemala, have the highest number of undocumented immigrants, with 261,000 and 253,000 individuals respectively. In Asia, China leads with 37,908 undocu-



mented individuals.

Sri Lanka Supports Adani **Group's Self-Funding for Colombo Port Project**

Cri Lanka's govern-**J**ment has expressed its support for the Adani-led conglomerate's decision to use its own resources to fund the ongoing deep-water container terminal project at the Colombo port. Ports Minister Bimal Rathnayaka emphasized that the government is eager to see the successful completion of the project, which is critical for the country's revenue generation.

In a recent statement, Rathnayaka confirmed that the Sri Lankan government had no objections to the Adani Group's decision to fund the Colombo West International Terminal (CWIT) project through its own internal accruals. This move follows a previous agreement by the US International Development Finance Corporation (DFC) to provide a USD 553 million loan to support the development and construction of the terminal. However, Adani Ports and SEZ Ltd announced in a filing on Tuesday that it would now proceed with the project using its own financial resources, aligning with its broader capital management strategy.

The CWIT project, part of the ongoing development of the Port of Colombo, is seen as a vital infrastructure project for Sri Lanka, with significant implications for the coun-



try's trade and economic growth. Rathnayaka highlighted the importance of the terminal, noting that it would contribute to both the port's revenue and the broader economy.

While the US-based DFC's funding was initially part of the plan, the Adani Group's decision to withdraw from the arrangement and fund the project independently has been described as an internal business decision. The Sri Lankan government, however, remains fully supportive, underscoring that the project's completion is a priority.

With the project scheduled for commissioning by early next year, the Adani-led initiative is expected to enhance the port's capacity, boosting Sri Lanka's position as a key player in global maritime trade.

India's Economic Recovery Expected in FY25, with Positive Outlook for Equity Markets

India's economic growth is expect-ed to rebound in the second half of FY25, driven by a recovery in government capital expenditure post-elections, rural consumption recovery, and strong festive season demand, according to a report by Motilal Oswal Private Wealth (MOPW). The report, titled the Alpha Strategist Report, highlights that India is poised to maintain its position as one of the fastest-growing major economies globally, characterized by stable growth and relatively low volatility.

The report notes that the Indian economy continues to show resilience, positioning the country for gradual growth as it recovers from

the recent slowdown. It also points out that the equity markets are currently in a consolidation phase, following a 10-12% correction in the benchmark indices. Despite the correction, the report indicates that large-cap valuations now appear attractive for investors.

In light of the market's recent performance, the report recommends that investors adopt a balanced strategy, considering lump-sum investments in Hybrid, Large, and Flexi-cap funds. For mid- and small-cap strategies, the report suggests a more staggered approach over three months to mitigate risks and capitalize on potential market rebounds.

The report also highlights the recent return of foreign institutional investors (FII) to the Indian markets, with a net infusion of Rs 9,947 crore after 38



sessions of net selling. This indicates growing investor confidence in India's economic recovery and prospects.

While maintaining a positive long-term outlook for the equity markets, the report advises caution, recommending that investors align their strategies based on their risk profiles. It suggests increasing equity allocation if it is lower than desired levels, using a lump-sum investment strategy for largecap and hybrid strategies and a phased approach for mid- and small-cap funds.

Regarding fixed income investments, the report suggests an overweight position in accrual strategies and a neutral stance on duration-based strategies, considering the evolving interest rate environment.

SEBI's review will focus on identifying potential changes to the rules that could encourage retail investors to adopt algorithmic strategies, while ensuring that safeguards are in place to prevent market disruptions and ensure investor protection.

The move is expected to create new opportunities for retail investors, empowering them to leverage the power of algorithms for better trade execution and portfolio management. It also aligns with SEBI's broader objective of enhancing market efficiency and fostering a more inclusive trading ecosystem.

US lawmakers have expressed fears about the app's data practices and its potential to be used for espionage, prompting calls for a ban or forced sale of the platform. TikTok has strongly denied these allegations, insisting that it stores US user data securely and operates independently from its Chinese parent company.



In their legal filings, TikTok and ByteDance emphasized the app's role as a vital platform for free speech and its deep integration into the daily lives of millions of Americans. They argued that the forced sale of the app could have far-reaching consequences, not only for users but also for content creators and businesses that rely on TikTok's unique platform for communication and commerce.

As the clock ticks down to the January 19 deadline, Tik-Tok's future in the US hangs in the balance, with both the company and its millions of users anxiously awaiting the outcome of their legal battle.


