
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Dy CM Delivers Promises Made During Palle Pandaga Celebrations

The residents of Penamaluru constituency, especially those in Kankipadu, Royyur, and Godavarru, are set to benefit from a major infrastructure improvement. Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan has overseen the rapid construction of a 5-kilometer road between Kankipadu bus stand and Royyur via Godavarru. What was once a road nearly impassable, causing great inconvenience to the residents, is now being transformed to ensure smooth travel. This improvement, promised by Pawan Kalyan during a village festival two months ago, will benefit about 21,000 people across the three villages.

During a recent inspection, Pawan Kalyan assessed the quality of the road construction, which is being funded by the National Employment Guarantee Scheme (NEGS) and State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF). He emphasized the importance of proper road layering and suggested that the entire old road be removed to ensure lasting quality. As of now, 3.63 kilometers of the road have been completed, with the final phase expected to be done by Sankranti. The total cost of the project is Rs. 3 crore. Local villagers expressed gratitude to Pawan Kalyan, recounting years of hardship due to the dilapidated road, which made transportation difficult for pregnant women and farmers. They praised the quick action taken by the Deputy Chief Minister, who personally ensured that the work adhered to high standards.

ED Issues Notices to MP Vijayasai Reddy in **Kakinada Port Case**

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has issued fresh notices in connection with the ongoing investigation into the Kakinada Port case. Notices have been served to Member of Parliament (MP) Vijayasai Reddy, his In Law, and P. Sarath Chandra Reddy of Aurobindo Pharma.

Previously, both MP Vijayasai Reddy and Sarath Chandra Reddy had been absent from the inquiry, citing health reasons related to Parliament meetings. The investigation centers around the flow of significant funds, particularly the Rs. 494 crore, with questions being raised about where the money came from and who provided it. This forms a critical aspect of the ongoing probe, as the ED seeks to understand how Aurobindo Pharma raised such a large sum.

Additionally, Vikrant Reddy, the son of YV Subbareddy, has already appeared for questioning. However, there are speculations that the ED may issue further notices to Vikrant Reddy, asking him to attend additional inquiries related to the case. The investigation is currently fo-

cused on tracing the source of the funds and examining any possible illegal financial activities linked to the port deal.



CM Naidu Approves ₹2,723 Crore Projects for Amaravati

In a significant boost to Amaravati's development, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu sanctioned ₹2,723 crore worth of construction projects in the capital city during a CRDA meeting held at the Secretariat On Monday.

This approval comes on the heels of recent funding approvals of ₹15,000 crore from the World Bank and the Asian Development Bank, marking a major financial commitment toward transforming Amaravati into a world-class city.

During the meeting, CM Naidu directed officials to expedite the completion of 1.18 lakh TIDCO houses and ensure their launch by June 12, 2025. Additionally, provisions for basic amenities in LPS Zone 7 and Zone 10 were prioritized. Discussions also centered on the progress of key infrastructure projects, including the Outer Ring Road for Amaravati and the Vijayawada bypass.

To date, the CRDA has sanctioned projects worth ₹47,288 crore in Amaravati. The state government has reiterated its commitment to establishing Amaravati as a global urban hub by implementing world-class infrastructure and facilities.

CM Naidu emphasized the importance of adhering to strict timelines to complete all major developments and instructed CRDA officials to work diligently toward realizing the capital city's ambitious vision.

Capital Development is on Track, No Reduction in Plans

Amaravati, Dec 24

Minister Narayana addressed the ongoing progress of Amaravati's development, assuring that the capital city is progressing as planned without any reduction in the scope of work. Speaking at the 44th CRDA Authority meeting, held under the leadership of Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, Narayana emphasized that the authority has approved Rs. 2723 crore for the development of Zone 7 and Zone 10 layouts. To date, the authority has given permission for Rs. 47,288 crore for the city's development, with approval for remaining works expected soon.

The Minister highlighted the Chief Minister's commitment to building good houses for the poor and ensuring that every woman and family is happy. The government has already been working on housing projects, with the Center allocating 7,01,481 houses. Administrative permission has been granted for 5,00,000 houses, and 4,54,706 of them have already been grounded. Narayana emphasized that the housing project had faced land disputes, but efforts have been made to resolve them, with three types of houses—300, 365, and 430 square feet—being built.

Minister Narayana further criticized the previous government for mismanaging the housing project and misallocating funds, which led to delays in construction. He said that Rs. 7,517 crore would be required to complete the ongoing projects, with 70,000 houses completed under the TDP government.

Narayana assured that the Chief Minister has directed that 18 lakh houses should be completed by June 12, 2024, and work will proceed with TID-CO to ensure timely completion. He also confirmed that the development of all 26 districts in the state would be carried out equally. Narayana reaffirmed that Amaravati will be built as planned, without burdening the people financially, and assured that the project would be completed within the next three years.

SIPC Meeting Chaired by CS Nirab Kumar Prasad to Review Investment Proposals

Rain Alert To AP, Severe Low Pressure Continues in West Bay of Bengal

A severe low pressure system continues to persist in the West Bay of Bengal, with its movement proving unpredictable. Initially, the Meteorological Department had estimated that the low pressure would weaken by Sunday, but its erratic movement has made it difficult to predict its future path.


The low pressure is currently moving west-southwestwards and is expected to move towards the south coast of North Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh by Tuesday. The Meteorological Department has warned that

several districts in Andhra Pradesh, including Tirupati, Nellore, Prakasam, and Bapatla. As a precaution, authorities have issued a third-level warning to the ports in the state. Fishermen are advised to refrain from going to sea until Thursday due to the adverse conditions.

The unpredictable movement of the low pressure system in the sea has complicated forecasting efforts. Meteorological officials stated that the remnants of the low pressure are moving towards the northern Tamil Nadu and southern Andhra Pradesh coasts. They also mentioned that such chaotic

moderate to heavy rainfall will affect conditions are rare, with no favorable conditions in the west-central Bay of Bengal contributing to the unusual behavior of the system. The impact of the severe low pressure is expected to last until Thursday, December 26. While it is unclear whether the low pressure will move closer to the coast or cross it, experts believe that the system, which began as a low pressure in the southeast Bay of Bengal on December 16, strengthened rapidly and now threatens the Andhra Pradesh coast.

Residents in the affected districts are advised to stay alert and take necessary precautions against the potential heavy rains and stormy conditions.

Minister Kollu Ravindra Slams Perni **Nani Over Missing Ration Rice Case**

Minister Kollu Ravindra has launched a sharp attack on YSRCP leader and former minister Perni Nani over the alleged misappropriation of ration rice in a godown. Ravindra criticized Perni Nani, questioning his silence on the issue and accusing him of moral hypocrisy.

"Where is Perni Nani, who often preaches morals? Why is he silent now? Those who steal rice meant for the poor should be treated like pigs," Ravindra said, alleging that Nani has failed to provide an explanation for the

He accused Perni Nani of profiting from wrongdoings and clarified that there is no justification for leaving those responsible for the scam unpunished. Ravindra also proposed the formation of a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to thoroughly probe the matter.

"If there was partisanship on our part, Nani and his entire family involved in the scam would already be in jail. Yet, we are advocating a fair investigation," Ravindra added.

Ravindra mocked Nani's apparent inability to respond to the allegations, stating that his silence and avoid-



ance make him appear guilty. "If you have done nothing wrong, why are you running away like a thief?" he questioned.

The missing ration rice case has sparked political controversy in Andhra Pradesh, with the opposition TDP intensifying its criticism of the ruling YSRCP over alleged mismanagement and corruption. Ravindra's remarks underscore the growing tensions between the two parties as they prepare for the upcoming elections.

Minister Atchannaidu Warns Wrongdoers, Criticizes YSRCP's Five-Year Rule

He specifically expressed outrage over the alleged conspiracy to murder TDP leader Nagaraju in Palasa through a "supari gang," labeling it as a cruel and unacceptable act.

The minister highlighted the coalition government's pro-farmer initiatives, emphasizing their commitment to farmer welfare. "In the past five years, farmers were deprived of a support price. We cleared the ₹1,600 crore arrears left by the previous government and ensured timely payments to farmers this year. Plans are in place to boost farmers' income with minimal invest-

MLA Somireddy Demands Comprehensive Probe into Alleged "Vijayasai Gang" Scams

TDP MLA Somireddy Chandramohan Reddy has demanded a thorough investigation into alleged scams involving YSRCP Rajya Sabha MP Vijayasai Reddy and his associates. He accused Vijayasai Reddy's subsidiary, Trident Knowledge Company, of supplying 4.5 lakh tons of substandard coal to APGENCO (Andhra Pradesh Power Generation Corporation), leading

to a decline in power generation.

Across the Atlantic, former U.S. President Donald Trump has made a surprising political comeback, reclaiming the White House with his brash, no-nonsense approach. His bold stance on foreign policy and business deregulation has earned him the support of powerful figures like Masayoshi Son and Gautam Adani, signaling the massive influence he continues to wield. Trump's foreign policy is grounded in non-interventionism, focusing on U.S. interests while allowing other global powers to manage their own conflicts. This shift in American strategy has forced allies like NATO and Israel to reevaluate their approach to security and diplomacy.

Meanwhile, in Turkey, President Recep Tayvip Erdogan has tackled a complex regional issue by backing rebel forces in Syria to evict Bashar al-Assad, dramatically shifting the power balance in the Middle East. His leadership has also challenged Russia's influence in the region, notably in the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict, where Turkey helped Azerbaijan wrest control from Armenia. These actions have reshaped alliances and given Erdogan greater leverage in the region.

In countries like Argentina, Pakistan, and Bangladesh, the window for drastic measures is narrowing. As the global political climate evolves, these nations may also see the rise of leaders willing to break from traditional approaches.

The Places of **Worship Act:** Unconstitutional, Immoral, and **Anti-Secular**



The Places of Worship (Special Provisions) Act, 1991, passed by the Congress-led Narasimha Rao government, was aimed at preserving social harmony during the aftermath of the Ayodhya dispute. However, its provisions are deeply flawed and violate the moral and constitutional fabric of India. The Act, rather than fostering secularism, condones past injustices and suppresses the Hindu community's rightful claims to religious spaces.

The crux of the Act lies in its two most controversial provisions: Section 3, which prohibits converting the religious character of any place of worship, and Section 4, which locks the status of places of worship as they existed on August 15, 1947, and bars any future legal challenges on these matters. By denying any recourse to judicial review, this Act fundamentally undermines the right of citizens to seek justice and redress through the courts. This provision contradicts the basic structure doctrine of the Indian Constitution, which guarantees the right to judicial review, as affirmed by the Supreme Court in various judgments, including Kesavananda Bharati and Anita Kushwaha v. Pushap Sudan.

Morally, the Places of Worship Act is deeply problematic. The Act maintains the status quo of places where Hindu temples were destroyed and mosques were built on their sites during periods of Muslim rule and colonialism. These acts of iconoclasm were not just crimes but a historical denial of the rights of Hindus. By preventing any legal challenges to these actions, the Act effectively condones these historical wrongs, giving them a form of legal legitimacy. This is morally indefensible, as it ignores the suffering and victimization of the Hindu community.

The Act also conflicts with the principles of secularism. Secularism is not about maintaining a false equilibrium by suppressing one community's rights to appease another. True secularism requires equal respect for all religions, and the Places of Worship Act, by denying justice to Hindus, undermines this fundamental tenet. Furthermore, it perpetuates communal disharmony by protecting the symbols of past religious intolerance under the guise of social peace.

Internationally, the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples emphasizes the need for restitution and protection of cultural and religious property. The Places of Worship Act, by denying Hindus the right to challenge the status of religious sites, directly violates this principle, further solidifying the Act's unjust nature.

In conclusion, the Places of Worship Act is an immoral and unconstitutional law that undermines justice, secularism, and the rights of Hindus. It must be struck down by the Supreme Court to restore the sanctity of India's democracy and uphold its commitment to justice and equality for all.

Hope for Organ Shortages: Towana Looney's Pioneering Pig Kidney Transplant

Last month, 53-year-old Towana Looney from Gadsden, Alabama, became the third person to receive a genetically engineered pig kidney in a groundbreaking xenotransplantation procedure. This significant advancement in animal-to-human organ transplants could pave the way for future treatments, potentially saving countless

Looney's medical journey has been challenging. After donating a kidney to her mother in 1999, she later developed high blood pressure during pregnancy, which led to kidney failure. Years of dialysis followed, but Looney faced even greater difficulty in finding a suitable kidney donor due to the antibodies in her body from previous blood transfusions. This left her with limited options for a transplant.



In a fortunate turn of events, Looney tentially help many patients in need was given the opportunity to receive of life-saving transplants. a pig kidney through an experimental program by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), which allows for the compassionate use of new treatments. Just three weeks after the transplant, her pig kidney appears to be functioning well. Although her immune system initially showed resistance, doctors managed to address the issue, and Looney is regaining her

Looney's participation in this experimental transplant is a significant step for the field of xenotransplantation. As the first successful case in this new phase, her experience could provide valuable insights and move the field closer to clinical trials, where genetically engineered pig organs could po-

At a recent press conference, Looney shared her joy about her recovery. "I'm overjoyed," she said, noting her increased energy and improved appetite after years of dialysis. For the first time in years, she's rediscovering simple pleasures, such as being able to use the bathroom normally and looking forward to traveling to places like Disney World.

Although every xenotransplant is an experiment, Looney's case is especially important, as it could represent a promising future for those who face long waits for organ donors. Her success offers hope to many more patients who desperately need new kidneys to survive.







Turned Dreams Of people Into Source Of Income: Priyanka Over GST On Exam Forms

"The BJP cannot provide jobs to youngsters, but it is definitely rubbing salt on the wounds by charging 18 per cent GST on examination forms," Priyanka wrote in her post. She also highlighted that GST was being levied on every government job form, including the Agniveer recruitment process.

The Congress leader further expressed her frustration with the situation, pointing out the potential consequences for students. "After filling the form, if the paper is leaked due to the government's failure or if there is corruption, then this money of the youngsters is wasted," she added, stressing the unfairness of the burden being placed on those hoping to secure employment or educational opportunities.

Her statement has drawn attention to the rising costs of examinations and the challenges faced by students and their families in an increasingly difficult economic climate. Priyanka Gandhi's comments add to ongoing discussions about government policies that critics say disproportionately affect middle and lower-income groups.



The Chief Minister expressed his gratitude to Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma for facilitating the training of Manipur's police recruits, given the security situation in Manipur. Biren Singh highlighted the strong historical relationship between Assam and Manipur, noting that Sarma had agreed to assist immediately when approached.

'They Will Dig Their Government': Akhilesh Yadav Attacks BJP Over Sambhal

Samajwadi Party Chief Akhilesh Yadav criticized the BJP government on Monday, following the ongoing excavation work in Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh, where a stepwell (baoli) was recently unearthed. Yadav humorously remarked that the BJP will continue its search and one day, by digging continuously, "end up digging their own government."

The statement came after an excavation team from the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) discovered a stepwell in the Chandausi area of Sambhal district on Sunday. District Magistrate Rajendra Pensiya confirmed the discovery of the stepwell, which spans an area of 400 square meters and includes four chambers. The structure is composed of marble floors in the second and third chambers, with the upper levels made of brick. According to local historians, this stepwell is believed to date back more than 150 years, possibly built during the time of the grandfather of the king of Bilari.

The unearthing of the stepwell follows the recent reopening of a Shiv-Hanuman temple in Sambhal that had been closed for 46 years. This temple reopening has sparked additional historical investigations in the region. The district magistrate noted that the stepwell could have been constructed



during the 19th century and further investigation would be conducted to learn more about its origins.

In addition to the stepwell discovery, an ASI team also surveyed the Kalki Vishnu temple in Sambhal, inspecting five shrines and 19 wells in the area. The inspection lasted between 8-10 hours and covered approximately 24 locations. The district magistrate stated that ASI would submit a report based on the findings from this survey.

The ongoing excavation work in Sambhal has caught the attention of local political figures, with Akhilesh Yadav making his remarks amid rising political tensions surrounding the excavation projects and historical findings in Uttar Pradesh.

Amendment To Conduct Of Election Rules Assault On Free And Fair Polls: MK Stalin

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin on Monday condemned the Union Government's recent amendment to the Conduct of Election Rules, describing it as an "undemocratic assault on free and fair elections." The amendment restricts public access to certain poll documents, a move Stalin claims undermines transparency and accountability in the electoral process.

The Ministry of Law and Justice amended the rules following a directive from the Punjab and Haryana High Court, which had ordered the Election Commission of India to release all documents related to the Haryana Assembly elections, including CCTV footage. Stalin criticized this amendment, asserting that it prevents public inspection of essential election materials, which he believes is a crucial aspect of ensuring electoral transparency.

Stalin described the amendment as an attempt to "kill the transparency in election," calling it a direct threat to the democratic principles enshrined in the Indian Constitution. He accused the BJP-led Union Government of using such amendments to control



the electoral process and suppress public scrutiny, suggesting that this move was indicative of the ruling party's growing insecurity.

The DMK president also pointed to the amendment as part of the BJP's larger fear of public exposure in election-related matters, referencing the controversial assembly elections in Maharashtra. He suggested that the "orchestrated and unholy victory" in Maharashtra had raised significant concerns regarding the integrity of the elections in states under BJP control.

Furthermore, Stalin expressed disappointment with the Election Commission of India, claiming that instead of defending its institutional integrity, the Commission had "succumbed to the pressure" from Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government.





UN 2024: India calls for change in world forum as conflicts persist

UNITED NATIONS: As the United Nations approaches its 80th anniversary, India has reiterated the importance of reform to maintain the organization's relevance in addressing global challenges. During the high-level 79th session of the General Assembly in September, world leaders adopted the ambitious 'Pact of the Future' by consensus. The pact addresses key themes such as peace and security, sustainable development, climate change, digital cooperation, human rights, gender, youth, and the transformation of global governance.

UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres emphasized the need for more effective and inclusive problem-solving mechanisms, stating, "We can't create a future fit for our grandchildren with systems built for our grandparents." He underscored that the current systems must evolve to meet the 21st century's challenges.

India, a long-time advocate for reform, has consistently called for changes to the Security Council, particularly regarding its expansion in both permanent and non-permanent categories. The country argues that the current structure, which was established in 1945, no longer



reflects contemporary geopolitical realities. India believes it is entitled to a permanent seat at the table to better represent the global land-

The failure of the Security Council to effectively address current global conflicts, such as the war in Ukraine and the Israel-Hamas conflict, highlights the necessity for reform. Guterres noted that many of the pressing issues facing the world today were not anticipated when the UN

framework was created 80 years ago.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi echoed these sentiments during his address at the UN's Summit of the Future, where the 'Pact of the Future' was adopted. He stated, "Reform is the key to relevance... Global action must match global ambition," calling for reforms that reflect the evolving dynamics of the world and ensure that the UN remains a robust and effective organization for the challenges of the 21st century.

North Korea Preparing to Send More Troops, Drones to Russia



SEOUL: North Korea is reportedly preparing to deploy additional troops and military equipment, including suicide drones, to Russia in support of its ongoing war in Ukraine, according to South Korea's military. The country's Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCS) stated on Monday that intelligence gathered indicates North Korea plans to increase its involvement in the conflict by rotating or expanding

its military presence in Russia.

The South Korean military's assessment follows reports that North Korea has already sent thousands of soldiers to fight alongside Russian forces in Ukraine. The number of North Korean casualties is estimated at around 1,100, highlighting the significant human cost of their parNorth Korea has been supplying Russia with artillery systems, including 240-millimeter rocket launchers and 170 mm self-propelled artillery.

Additionally, there are signs that North Korea is working to manufacture and supply suicide drones, a weapon type first showcased by Kim Jong-un during a military inspection in November. The drones are seen as a vital tool in modern warfare due to their low cost and high effectiveness. North Korea's decision to ramp up the production of these drones aligns with its broader strategy to gain valuable battlefield experience and modernize its conventional weapons

The move also highlights the deepening military ties between North Korea and Russia, with both nations increasingly relying on each other amidst international sanctions and isolation. While there have been no direct signs of provocation from North Korea in recent days, its growing cooperation with Russia signals a significant shift in the region's security dynamics. The increased deployment of troops and arms supplies from North Korea may further complicate the situation in Ukraine and add to global concerns over the proticipation. Don't Need "Proxy Force" To Take Action: Iran Ayatollah's Latest Warning



IRAN: Iran's Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, denied claims that Tehran uses militant groups in the region as proxies, insisting that if Iran were to take military action, it would do so without relying on outside forces. The comments came after a year marked by heavy losses for Iran-backed Hezbollah in Lebanon and Hamas in Gaza, as well as the recent fall of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, a longtime ally of Tehran.

Khamenei's remarks challenge the widespread perception that groups like Hezbollah, Hamas, and Yemen's Huthi rebels act as Tehran's proxies. These groups, often aligned with Iran's strategic goals, have faced military setbacks in their respective regions, notably during the Israel-Hamas conflict and U.S.led strikes on the Huthis. Khamenei, however, emphasized that these groups are motivated by their own beliefs and not by orders from Tehran.

"The Islamic Republic does not have a proxy force," Khamenei told visitors in Tehran. He continued, "Yemen fights because it has faith. Hezbollah fights because the power of faith draws it into the field. Hamas and Jihad fight because their beliefs compel them to do so." Khamenei dismissed American claims that Iran had lost its proxies in the region, adding that Iran would not need such groups if it chose to take direct action. Khamenei also commented on the recent developments in Syria, where Assad's regime faced significant challenges from rebel forces, which culminated in the loss of Damascus. Khamenei predicted that Syria would see the emergence of "a strong, honorable group" to counter what he described as foreign-imposed insecurity.

We Want Her Here: Bangladesh **Asks India To Send Back Deposed PM Sheikh Hasina**

DHAKA: Bangladesh's interim government announced on Monday that it has formally requested India to return deposed Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to Dhaka. Hasina, 77, has been living in exile in India since August 5, after fleeing the country amid widespread student-led protests that resulted in the fall of her 16-year rule.

The Dhaka-based International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) issued arrest warrants for Hasina, along with several former cabinet ministers, advisers, and military and civil officials, for alleged "crimes against humanity and genocide." In response to this, Bangladesh's Foreign Affairs Adviser, Touhid Hossain, confirmed that a diplomatic note, also known as a "note verbale," has been sent to the Indian government requesting Hasina's extradition.

"We have sent a note verbale to the Indian government saying that Bangladesh wants her back here for the judicial process," Hossain told reporters at his office. He added that the government is actively pursuing the legal process to bring Hasina back to face charges.

In parallel, Home Advisor Jahangir Alam revealed that a letter has been sent to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Bangladesh to facilitate the former prime minister's extradition from India. Alam emphasized that an existing extradition treaty between Bangladesh and India could be used to bring Hasina back to her home country.

The demand for Hasina's return is part of ongoing legal and political tensions in Bangladesh. The exiled leader's return could mark a significant development in the ongoing judicial process related to her alleged involvement in various crimes. Hasina's time in exile, which began following the collapse of her government, has been a point of contention, especially given the legal actions now being pursued against her by the Bangladesh government.

Bangladeshi Traders "Forced" To Import From Pakistan **Amid Growing Maritime Ties**

DHAKA: rade and maritime relations between Pakistan and Bangladesh are strengthening, with the recent arrival of a second cargo vessel from Karachi to the Chittagong port, sparking concerns in India. The Panama-flagged vessel, 'MV Yuan Xiang Fa Zhan,' entered Bangladeshi waters on Sunday, carrying 811 containers of essential industrial goods like soda ash, dolomite, and marble blocks, along with consumer products such as garments raw materials, sugar, and electronics. This follows the arrival of a similar vessel earlier in the week.

This development coincides with a meeting between Bangladesh's interim leader, Professor Muhammad Yunus, and Pakistan's Prime Minister



Shehbaz Sharif in Cairo, where the two countries agreed to strengthen bilateral relations. Reports suggest that Bangladesh's traders are increasingly

being pushed to import goods from Pakistan, prompting some officials to suggest reviewing the India-Bangladesh shipping pact, which currently

grants India access to the Chittagong and Mongla ports.

Chittagong Port holds significant strategic value, located in the Bay of Bengal, and has been closely monitored by India. Historically, India has kept a close eye on activities at the port, particularly after a 2004 incident where 1,500 boxes of Chinese ammunition, allegedly linked to Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI), were confiscated at the port. The consignment was reportedly meant for the insurgent group ULFA in India's north-

India is also concerned about a potential resurgence of Islamist extremism in Bangladesh, which could threaten

its security. In a move that adds to these worries, Bangladesh recently lifted a policy requiring physical inspections of Pakistani cargo at Chittagong, making it easier for Pakistan to utilize the port without scrutiny. This change, along with the resumption of direct maritime trade between Bangladesh and Pakistan, marks a significant shift in relations, particularly under Yunus, who has taken steps to improve ties with Islamabad since assuming office in August.

The growing Bangladesh-Pakistan ties are seen as a reversal of the pro-India policies of former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, raising alarm in New Delhi over the implications for regional security.



Oil Prices Settle Flat Amid Chinese Demand and U.S. Inflation Data



HOUSTON (Reuters) – Oil prices closed little changed on Friday as markets weighed concerns over Chinese demand alongside expectations of interest rate cuts following data showing cooling U.S. inflation.

Brent crude futures rose by 6 cents, or 0.08%, closing at \$72.94 a barrel. Meanwhile, U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures gained 8 cents, or 0.12%, to settle at \$69.46 per barrel. Despite the slight uptick, both benchmarks ended the week approximately 2.5% lower.

The U.S. dollar, which had reached a two-year high earlier in the week, retreated after inflation data indicated a slowdown in November. This brought relief to markets, as it followed the Federal Reserve's decision to cut interest rates, although the central bank also reduced its outlook for further rate cuts in 2025. A weaker dollar typically makes oil more affordable for buyers using other currencies, while potential rate cuts could stimulate oil demand.

John Kilduff, partner at Again Capital in New York, remarked that concerns about the Fed potentially halting its support for the market had faded. However, he acknowledged the ongoing worries about the demand outlook, particularly in China. The Chinese government's forecast that oil consumption would peak by 2027 and the weakening demand for diesel and gasoline raised doubts about the strength of global demand.

Emril Jamil, a senior research specialist at LSEG, emphasized that OPEC+ needed to maintain supply discipline to calm market nerves amid continuous revisions to the demand forecast. OPEC+ recently downgraded its global oil demand growth projection for 2024 for the fifth consecutive month.

JPMorgan forecast that the oil market would transition from balance in 2024 to a surplus of 1.2 million barrels per day in 2025, driven by rising non-OPEC+ production.

India's savings rate surpasses global average amid rising financial inclusion: SBI report



Tndia's savings rate has **■** surpassed the global average, reaching 30.2%, higher than the global average of 28.2%, according to a report released by the State Bank of India (SBI) on Monday. The report highlights the growing financial inclusion in the country, noting that over 80% of Indian adults now have formal financial accounts, a significant improvement from around 50% in 2011.

The increase in financial inclusion has contributed to a higher financialisation Household investment in of household savings. The report states that the share of net financial savings in total household savings has grown from 36% in FY14 to 52% in FY21. However, there has been a slight deceleration in this trend during FY22 and FY23. In FY24, trends show that the share of physical savings is once again on the decline, with more people turning to financial products.

As new investment avenues such as mutual funds gain popularity, the share of bank deposits and currency in household financial savings is decreasing. The SBI research also pointed out that, in the past decade, Indian companies have significantly increased their fund-raising from capital markets, with the amount raised surging more than ten-fold, from Rs 12,068 crore in FY14 to Rs 1.21 lakh crore in FY25 (up to October).


