TPN, Telangana : Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka announced that permissions for the construction of the Regional Ring Road (RRR) have been secured, and tenders will be called shortly. Speaking at a bankers' meeting at Praja Bhavan, he urged financial institutions to adopt a long-term

perspective to support Telangana's growth. Bhatti highlighted that the state government has achieved 81.57% of its target for Kharif season loans, disbursing ₹44,438 crore out of the ₹54,480 crore target. He urged banks to expedite the distribution of Rabi loans, with only a month left for completion.

The Deputy CM emphasized the government's commitment to supporting farmers, revealing that ₹21,000 crore has been deposited into banks under the farmer loan waiver scheme in just two months. Additionally, interest-free loans worth ₹20,000 crore are provided annually to transform beneficiaries into entrepreneurs.

# Hospital Delay Hurts Poor: Harish Rao

**Rao Accuses Congress of Stalling Key Healthcare Project** Warangal Super Specialty Hospital Remains Stagnant Rao Urges Government to Speed Up Construction Hospital to Provide Advanced Care for North Telangana

ish Rao criticized the Congress government for its negligence in advancing the construction of the 24-storey super specialty hospital in Warangal district, a project initiated by KCR to provide high-quality medical care to the poor. During his visit to the site, Harish Rao expressed disappointment over the lack of progress despite the ambitious plans laid out by the Telangana government.

Harish Rao highlighted that the hospital, envisioned as a corporate-level facility for the underprivileged, was designed to accommodate 2,000 beds. The project also expanded its floor space from 1,600 SFT to 2,000 SFT to better serve the healthcare needs of North

Following the remarks by CM Revanth Reddy in the assembly and a subsequent media conference by actor Allu Arjun, the incident has sparked widespread public attention.

In response, the Telangana Film Chamber of Commerce has taken a

Exhibitors from Andhra Pradesh also praised Revanth Reddy's decision, expressing hope that the AP government would follow suit. They highlighted the inconvenience caused to moviegoers by rising ticket prices and urged a similar review of ticket rates in their state.

# **Manchu Family Feud Escalates**

TPN, Hyderabad : A fresh controversy has erupted in the Manchu family as actor Manchu Manoj has filed a complaint against his brother, Manchu Vishnu, and six others. The seven-page complaint alleges harassment, conspiracy, and threats to Manoj and his family.

In his complaint, Manoj accused Vishnu and his associates— Vinay Maheshwari, Vijay Reddy, Kiran, Raj Konduru, Shiva, and Vannuru—of causing harm to him, his wife, and his children. The allegations include a misuse of funds in Mohan Babu University and its associated trust. Manoj claimed that he was targeted for exposing financial irregularities and was subjected to intimidation tactics.

#### Key Allegations in the Complaint

1. Threats to Life: Manoj alleged that Vishnu and his followers conspired to harm him and his family, even threatening their lives.

**2. Tampering with Utilities:** He claimed that a fake letter was sent to the electricity department, allegedly signed by him, to cut off power to his house. Additionally, he stated that the water supply to his house was intentionally stopped.

3. Mental Harassment: Manoj alleged that Vishnu and his associates were mentally torturing him to force him out of his house.



Manoj further requested police protection for himself and his family, citing ongoing threats.

The feud within the prominent Tollywood family has shocked fans and the film industry. While Vishnu has yet to respond to the allegations, the police are reportedly examining the complaint and are expected to initiate an investigation.

This rift has cast a shadow over the Manchu family, raising questions about the alleged misuse of funds and internal conflicts within one of Telugu cinema's most influential families.

#### MLC Kavitha Accuses CM Revanth of Betraying Farmers

TPN , Hyderabad: BRS MLC Kavitha has launched a scathing attack on Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, accusing him of adopting a "two-faced attitude" by making promises during elections and reneging on them after coming to power. Kavitha alleged that the Congress-led state government is attempting to auction the lands of farmers who have taken loans from Primary Agricultural Cooperative Credit Societies.

## Nakshatra Hotel Staff **Allegedly Attacks Customers**

TPN, Vikarabad: In a shocking incident near Chittempalli Gate in Pudur Mandal, employees of Nakshatra Hotel reportedly attacked villagers from Ghanpuram, Chevella Mandal, with lathis.

The incident occurred when the villagers raised a complaint about a scabbard (gasni) found in their biryani. They informed the hotel staff, who escalated the matter to the management. Allegedly, the hotel owner confronted the villagers and accused them of causing trouble during their visits.

Following this, the hotel staff reportedly followed the villagers and attacked them with lathis, leaving the victims injured and shaken. The victims have alleged that the management acted with



hostility and used excessive force without provocation.

The police have been informed of the incident, and an investigation is underway. Local residents have condemned the actions of the hotel staff and demanded strict action against those responsible. Authorities are urged to ensure justice for the victims and prevent such incidents in the future.

While releasing the 2024 annual report of the Cyber Security Bureau. Shikha Goval revealed a troubling rise in cyber crimes, which have increased by 18-20% this year. She noted that the Bureau has recovered ₹176 crore and returned it to the victims. Additionally, 1,057 cyber criminals have been arrested, with involvement in 19 cases in Telangana. The investigation into the incident continues, with authorities working to determine the circumstances surrounding the stampede.

The Places of **Worship Act: Unconstitutional**, Immoral, and **Anti-Secular** 



The Places of Worship (Special Provisions) Act, 1991, passed by the Congress-led Narasimha Rao government, was aimed at preserving social harmony during the aftermath of the Ayodhya dispute. However, its provisions are deeply flawed and violate the moral and constitutional fabric of India. The Act, rather than fostering secularism, condones past injustices and suppresses the Hindu community's rightful claims to religious spaces.

The crux of the Act lies in its two most controversial provisions: Section 3, which prohibits converting the religious character of any place of worship, and Section 4, which locks the status of places of worship as they existed on August 15, 1947, and bars any future legal challenges on these matters. By denying any recourse to judicial review, this Act fundamentally undermines the right of citizens to seek justice and redress through the courts. This provision contradicts the basic structure doctrine of the Indian Constitution, which guarantees the right to judicial review, as affirmed by the Supreme Court in various judgments, including Kesavananda Bharati and Anita Kushwaha v. Pushap Sudan.

Morally, the Places of Worship Act is deeply problematic. The Act maintains the status quo of places where Hindu temples were destroyed and mosques were built on their sites during periods of Muslim rule and colonialism. These acts of iconoclasm were not just crimes but a historical denial of the rights of Hindus. By preventing any legal challenges to these actions, the Act effectively condones these historical wrongs, giving them a form of legal legitimacy. This is morally indefensible, as it ignores the suffering and victimization of the Hindu community.

One such leader is Argentina's President Javier Milei, who, after defeating Peronist candidate Sergio Massa, launched a campaign centered on drastic economic reforms. A self-described anarcho-capitalist, Milei famously wielded a chainsaw to symbolize his intention to dismantle Argentina's bloated public sector. He slashed government spending on infrastructure, education, healthcare, and social services, and took a hard line against inflation, which had crippled the nation. Milei's shock therapy has shown some signs of success, with inflation dropping from 211% to 193%, and foreign reserves rising by \$11 billion. However, the reforms have also led to rising unemployment and increased poverty. While the economy is stabilizing, Milei's success or failure will depend on whether the short-term pain leads to long-term gain.

Across the Atlantic, former U.S. President Donald Trump has made a surprising political comeback, reclaiming the White House with his brash, no-nonsense approach. His bold stance on foreign policy and business deregulation has earned him the support of powerful figures like Masayoshi Son and Gautam Adani, signaling the massive influence he continues to wield. Trump's foreign policy is grounded in non-interventionism, focusing on U.S. interests while allowing other global powers to manage their own conflicts. This shift in American strategy has forced allies like NATO and Israel to reevaluate their approach to security and diplomacy.

Meanwhile, in Turkey, President Recep Tayyip Erdogan has tackled a complex regional issue by backing rebel forces in Syria to evict Bashar al-Assad, dramatically shifting the power balance in the Middle East. His leadership has also challenged Russia's influence in the region, notably in the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict, where Turkey helped Azerbaijan wrest control from Armenia. These actions have reshaped alliances and given Erdogan greater leverage in the region.

In countries like Argentina, Pakistan, and Bangladesh, the window for drastic measures is narrowing. As the global political climate evolves, these nations may also see the rise of leaders willing to break from traditional approaches.

The Act also conflicts with the principles of secularism. Secularism is not about maintaining a false equilibrium by suppressing one community's rights to appease another. True secularism requires equal respect for all religions, and the Places of Worship Act, by denying justice to Hindus, undermines this fundamental tenet. Furthermore, it perpetuates communal disharmony by protecting the symbols of past religious intolerance under the guise of social peace.

Internationally, the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples emphasizes the need for restitution and protection of cultural and religious property. The Places of Worship Act, by denying Hindus the right to challenge the status of religious sites, directly violates this principle, further solidifying the Act's unjust nature.

In conclusion, the Places of Worship Act is an immoral and unconstitutional law that undermines justice, secularism, and the rights of Hindus. It must be struck down by the Supreme Court to restore the sanctity of India's democracy and uphold its commitment to justice and equality for all.

#### Hope for Organ Shortages: Towana Looney's Pioneering Pig Kidney Transplant

Last month, 53-year-old Towana Looney from Gadsden, Alabama, became the third person to receive a genetically engineered pig kidney in a groundbreaking xenotransplantation procedure. This significant advancement in animal-to-human organ transplants could pave the way for future treatments, potentially saving countless lives.

Looney's medical journey has been challenging. After donating a kidney to her mother in 1999, she later developed high blood pressure during pregnancy, which led to kidney failure. Years of dialysis followed, but Looney faced even greater difficulty in finding a suitable kidney donor due to the antibodies in her body from previous blood transfusions. This left her with limited options for a transplant.

Just three weeks after the transplant, her pig kidney appears to be functioning well. Although every xenotransplant is an experiment, Looney's case is especially important, as it could represent a promising future for those who face long waits for organ donors. Her success offers hope to many more patients who desperately need new kidneys to survive.







#### Turned Dreams Of people Into Source Of Income: Priyanka Over GST On Exam Forms

Speaking to reporters after reviewing the preparations for the event, which will take place from January 13 to February 26, 2025, CM Adityanath highlighted the extensive efforts being made to ensure its success.

"The preparations for the Sanatan Gaurav Maha Kumbh are progressing well. Over 20,000 saints and institutions have been allocated land through a comprehensive registration process," the Chief Minister stated. This includes all 13 Akharas and various other religious groups. He assured that efforts are being made to complete the land allocation by January 5, 2025.

The Chief Minister also mentioned the increased number of pontoon bridges for the event, with the number rising from 22 to 30, 20 of which are already completed. Additionally, significant progress is being made on the infrastructure front, with 330 kilometers of checkered plates laid and 250 signages installed across the city and fairgrounds.

Water management efforts include ensuring a clean and uninterrupted flow of the Ganga, with the Irrigation Department working to maintain sufficient water levels. #### 'They Will Dig Their Government': Akhilesh Yadav Attacks BJP Over Sambhal

Samajwadi Party Chief Akhilesh Yadav criticized the BJP government on Monday, following the ongoing excavation work in Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh, where a stepwell (baoli) was recently unearthed. Yadav humorously remarked that the BJP will continue its search and one day, by digging continuously, "end up digging their own government."

The statement came after an excavation team from the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) discovered a stepwell in the Chandausi area of Sambhal district on Sunday. District Magistrate Rajendra Pensiya confirmed the discovery of the stepwell, which spans an area of 400 square meters and includes four chambers. The structure is composed of marble floors in the second and third chambers, with the upper levels made of brick. According to local historians, this stepwell is believed to date back more than 150 years, possibly built during the time of the grandfather of the king of Bilari.

The unearthing of the stepwell follows the recent reopening of a Shiv-Hanuman temple in Sambhal that had been closed for 46 years. This temple reopening has sparked additional historical investigations in the region. The district magistrate noted that the stepwell could have been constructed



during the 19th century and further investigation would be conducted to learn more about its origins.

In addition to the stepwell discovery, an ASI team also surveyed the Kalki Vishnu temple in Sambhal, inspecting five shrines and 19 wells in the area. The inspection lasted between 8-10 hours and covered approximately 24 locations. The district magistrate stated that ASI would submit a report based on the findings from this survey.

The ongoing excavation work in Sambhal has caught the attention of local political figures, with Akhilesh Yadav making his remarks amid rising political tensions surrounding the excavation projects and historical findings in Uttar Pradesh.

#### **Amendment To Conduct Of Election Rules Assault On Free And Fair Polls: MK Stalin**

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin on Monday condemned the Union Government's recent amendment to the Conduct of Election Rules, describing it as an "undemocratic assault on free and fair elections." The amendment restricts public access to certain poll documents, a move Stalin claims undermines transparency and accountability in the electoral process.

The Ministry of Law and Justice amended the rules following a directive from the Punjab and Haryana High Court, which had ordered the Election Commission of India to release all documents related to the Haryana Assembly elections, including CCTV footage. Stalin criticized this amendment, asserting that it prevents public inspection of essential election materials, which he believes is a crucial aspect of ensuring electoral transparency.

Stalin described the amendment as an attempt to "kill the transparency in election," calling it a direct threat to the democratic principles enshrined in the Indian Constitution. He accused the BJP-led Union Government of using such amendments to control



the electoral process and suppress public scrutiny, suggesting that this move was indicative of the ruling party's growing insecurity.

The DMK president also pointed to the amendment as part of the BJP's larger fear of public exposure in election-related matters, referencing the controversial assembly elections in Maharashtra. He suggested that the "orchestrated and unholy victory" in Maharashtra had raised significant concerns regarding the integrity of the elections in states under BJP control.

Furthermore, Stalin expressed disappointment with the Election Commission of India, claiming that instead of defending its institutional integrity, the Commission had "succumbed to the pressure" from Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government.





# **UN 2024: India calls for change in** world forum as conflicts persist

UNITED NATIONS: As the United Nations approaches its 80th anniversary, India has reiterated the importance of reform to maintain the organization's relevance in addressing global challenges. During the high-level 79th session of the General Assembly in September, world leaders adopted the ambitious 'Pact of the Future' by consensus. The pact addresses key themes such as peace and security, sustainable development, climate change, digital cooperation, human rights, gender, youth, and the transformation of global governance.

UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres emphasized the need for more effective and inclusive problem-solving mechanisms, stating, "We can't create a future fit for our grandchildren with systems built for our grandparents." He underscored that the current systems must evolve to meet the 21st century's challenges.

India, a long-time advocate for reform, has consistently called for changes to the Security Council, particularly regarding its expansion in both permanent and non-permanent categories. The country argues that the current structure, which was established in 1945, no longer



reflects contemporary geopolitical realities. India believes it is entitled to a permanent seat at the table to better represent the global landscape.

The failure of the Security Council to effectively address current global conflicts, such as the war in Ukraine and the Israel-Hamas conflict, highlights the necessity for reform. Guterres noted that many of the pressing issues facing the world today were not anticipated when the UN

framework was created 80 years ago.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi echoed these sentiments during his address at the UN's Summit of the Future, where the 'Pact of the Future' was adopted. He stated, "Reform is the key to relevance... Global action must match global ambition," calling for reforms that reflect the evolving dynamics of the world and ensure that the UN remains a robust and effective organization for the challenges of the 21st century.

#### **Don't Need "Proxy Force" To Take Action: Iran Ayatollah's Latest Warning**



IRAN: Iran's Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, denied claims that Tehran uses militant groups in the region as proxies, insisting that if Iran were to take military action, it would do so without relying on outside forces. The comments came after a year marked by heavy losses for Iran-backed Hezbollah in Lebanon and Hamas in Gaza, as well as the recent fall of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, a longtime ally of Tehran.

Khamenei's remarks challenge the widespread perception that groups like Hezbollah, Hamas, and Yemen's Huthi rebels act as Tehran's proxies. These groups, often aligned with Iran's strategic goals, have faced military setbacks in their respective regions, notably during the Israel-Hamas conflict and U.S.led strikes on the Huthis. Khamenei, however, emphasized that these groups are motivated by their own beliefs and not by orders from Tehran.

"The Islamic Republic does not have a proxy force," Khamenei told visitors in Tehran. He continued, "Yemen fights because it has faith. Hezbollah fights because the power of faith draws it into the field. Hamas and Jihad fight because their beliefs compel them to do so." Khamenei dismissed American claims that Iran had lost its proxies in the region, adding that Iran would not need such groups if it chose to take direct action. Khamenei also commented on the recent developments in Syria, where Assad's regime faced significant challenges from rebel forces, which culminated in the loss of Damascus. Khamenei predicted that Syria would see the emergence of "a strong, honorable group" to counter what he described as foreign-imposed insecurity.

#### We Want Her Here: Bangladesh **Asks India To Send Back Deposed PM Sheikh Hasina**

DHAKA: Bangladesh's interim government announced on Monday that it has formally requested India to return deposed Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to Dhaka. Hasina, 77, has been living in exile in India since August 5, after fleeing the country amid widespread student-led protests that resulted in the fall of her 16-year rule.

The Dhaka-based International Crimes Tribunal (ICT) issued arrest warrants for Hasina, along with several former cabinet ministers, advisers, and military and civil officials, for alleged "crimes against humanity and genocide." In response to this, Bangladesh's Foreign Affairs Adviser, Touhid Hossain, confirmed that a diplomatic note, also known as a "note verbale," has been sent to the Indian government requesting Hasina's extradition.

The South Korean military's assessment follows reports that North Korea has already sent thousands of soldiers to fight alongside Russian forces in Ukraine. The number of North Korean casualties is estimated at around 1,100, highlighting the significant human cost of their par-

The move also highlights the deepening military ties between North Korea and Russia, with both nations increasingly relying on each other amidst international sanctions and isolation. While there have been no direct signs of provocation from North Korea in recent days, its growing cooperation with Russia signals a significant shift in the region's security dynamics. The increased deployment of troops and arms supplies from North Korea may further complicate the situation in Ukraine and add to global concerns over the proticipation. The JCS also revealed that liferation of military technologies.

"We have sent a note verbale to the Indian government saying that Bangladesh wants her back here for the judicial process," Hossain told reporters at his office. He added that the government is actively pursuing the legal process to bring Hasina back to face charges.

In parallel, Home Advisor Jahangir Alam revealed that a letter has been sent to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Bangladesh to facilitate the former prime minister's extradition from India. Alam emphasized that an existing extradition treaty between Bangladesh and India could be used to bring Hasina back to her home country.

The demand for Hasina's return is part of ongoing legal and political tensions in Bangladesh. The exiled leader's return could mark a significant development in the ongoing judicial process related to her alleged involvement in various crimes. Hasina's time in exile, which began following the collapse of her government, has been a point of contention, especially given the legal actions now being pursued against her by the Bangladesh government.

## Bangladeshi Traders "Forced" To Import From Pakistan **Amid Growing Maritime Ties**

DHAKA: rade and maritime relations between Pakistan and Bangladesh are strengthening, with the recent arrival of a second cargo vessel from Karachi to the Chittagong port, sparking concerns in India. The Panama-flagged vessel, 'MV Yuan Xiang Fa Zhan,' entered Bangladeshi waters on Sunday, carrying 811 containers of essential industrial goods like soda ash, dolomite, and marble blocks, along with consumer products such as garments raw materials, sugar, and electronics. This follows the arrival of a similar vessel earlier in the week.

This development coincides with a meeting between Bangladesh's interim leader, Professor Muhammad Yunus, and Pakistan's Prime Minister



Shehbaz Sharif in Cairo, where the two countries agreed to strengthen bilateral relations. Reports suggest that Bangladesh's traders are increasingly

being pushed to import goods from Pakistan, prompting some officials to suggest reviewing the India-Bangladesh shipping pact, which currently

grants India access to the Chittagong and Mongla ports.

Chittagong Port holds significant strategic value, located in the Bay of Bengal, and has been closely monitored by India. Historically, India has kept a close eye on activities at the port, particularly after a 2004 incident where 1,500 boxes of Chinese ammunition, allegedly linked to Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI), were confiscated at the port. The consignment was reportedly meant for the insurgent group ULFA in India's northeast.

India is also concerned about a potential resurgence of Islamist extremism in Bangladesh, which could threaten

its security. In a move that adds to these worries, Bangladesh recently lifted a policy requiring physical inspections of Pakistani cargo at Chittagong, making it easier for Pakistan to utilize the port without scrutiny. This change, along with the resumption of direct maritime trade between Bangladesh and Pakistan, marks a significant shift in relations, particularly under Yunus, who has taken steps to improve ties with Islamabad since assuming office in August.

The growing Bangladesh-Pakistan ties are seen as a reversal of the pro-India policies of former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, raising alarm in New Delhi over the implications for regional security.

#### **Oil Prices Settle Flat Amid Chinese Demand** and U.S. Inflation Data



HOUSTON (Reuters) – Oil prices closed little changed on Friday as markets weighed concerns over Chinese demand alongside expectations of interest rate cuts following data showing cooling U.S. inflation.

Brent crude futures rose by 6 cents, or 0.08%, closing at \$72.94 a barrel. Meanwhile, U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures gained 8 cents, or 0.12%, to settle at \$69.46 per barrel. Despite the slight uptick, both benchmarks ended the week approximately 2.5% lower.

The U.S. dollar, which had reached a two-year high earlier in the week, retreated after inflation data indicated a slowdown in November. This brought relief to markets, as it followed the Federal Reserve's decision to cut interest rates, although the central bank also reduced its outlook for further rate cuts in 2025. A weaker dollar typically makes oil more affordable for buyers using other currencies, while potential rate cuts could stimulate oil demand.

John Kilduff, partner at Again Capital in New York, remarked that concerns about the Fed potentially halting its support for the market had faded. However, he acknowledged the ongoing worries about the demand outlook, particularly in China. The Chinese government's forecast that oil consumption would peak by 2027 and the weakening demand for diesel and gasoline raised doubts about the strength of global demand.

Emril Jamil, a senior research specialist at LSEG, emphasized that OPEC+ needed to maintain supply discipline to calm market nerves amid continuous revisions to the demand forecast. OPEC+ recently downgraded its global oil demand growth projection for 2024 for the fifth consecutive month.

JPMorgan forecast that the oil market would transition from balance in 2024 to a surplus of 1.2 million barrels per day in 2025, driven by rising non-OPEC+ production.



India's savings rate surpasses global average amid rising financial inclusion: SBI report

∎ndia's savings rate has surpassed the global average, reaching 30.2%, higher than the global average of 28.2%, according to a report released by the State Bank of India (SBI) on Monday. The report highlights the growing financial inclusion in the country, noting that over 80% of Indian adults now have formal financial accounts, a significant improvement from around 50% in 2011.

The increase in financial inclusion has contributed to a higher financialisation Household investment in of household savings. The report states that the share of net financial savings in total household savings has grown from 36% in FY14 to 52% in FY21. However, there has been a slight deceleration in this trend during FY22 and FY23. In FY24, trends show that the share of physical savings is once again on the decline, with more people turning to financial products.

As new investment avenues such as mutual funds gain popularity, the share of bank deposits and currency in household financial savings is decreasing. The SBI research also pointed out that, in the past decade, Indian companies have significantly increased their fund-raising from capital markets, with the amount raised surging more than ten-fold, from Rs 12,068 crore in FY14 to Rs 1.21 lakh crore in FY25 (up to October).

shares and debentures has also grown, reaching around 1% of GDP in FY24, up from just 0.2% in FY14. Additionally, the share of household financial savings invested in these areas has increased from 1% to 5%. This indicates that Indian households are now playing a more substantial role in funding the country's capital needs.

### **HDFC Securities Projects India's GDP Growth** at 6.4% in 2024-25

HDFC Securities has projected In-dia's GDP growth for 2024-25 at 6.4%, citing potential downside risks due to a slowdown in urban demand and a lack of substantial revival in private capital expenditure (capex). While these factors present challenges, the firm also pointed to growing rural demand and an expected increase in government spending as key drivers for economic growth.

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) had recently revised its growth forecast for the same period, lowering it to 6.6% from the earlier 7.2%. The downward revision followed a 5.4% real GDP growth in the July-Septem-



ber quarter of the 2024-25 financial year, a significant miss from the RBI's earlier es-

timate of 7%. The lower-than-expected quarterly growth has raised concerns about the pace of recovery in the economy.

HDFC Securities noted that despite the weaker-than-anticipated performance in the first half of the fiscal year, India's economy is expected to recover in the coming years. For FY 2025-26, the firm forecasts a modest improvement in GDP growth to 6.7%. This suggests that while the short-term outlook may be tempered, long-term growth expectations remain optimistic, driven by factors like rural consumption and government expenditure, which are likely to provide a cushion against the urban slowdown.



The victory puts Real Madrid in strong contention for the La Liga title as they head into the winter break, with Atletico Madrid still leading the table.






