Perni Nani Denies Escape Allegations, Calls Out False Propaganda



TPN Correspondent Tadepalli, Dec 29

Former minister and YSRCP leader Perni Nani refuted allegations of fleeing, asserting that he has been in Machilipatnam for three days since December 15. Speaking to the media in Tadepalli, Nani clarified that his absence from the public eye was based on legal advice from his lawyers.

Expressing frustration, Nani criticized the rampant rumors on social media, which he claimed overshadowed the ongoing police investigation. "I have not escaped anywhere. False propaganda is being spread against me, and I am being portrayed as a thief even before the facts are established," he remarked.

The former minister revealed that rice bags stored in his godown had decreased, and he had already made payments in cash. However, he alleged that cases were filed against him as part of a deliberate conspiracy. Perni Nani further accused certain groups of plotting his and his son's arrest by January 2. "There is more noise on social media than clarity in the police investigation," he said, adding that he is unable to comment on all issues due to the pending verdict on his bail petition, expected on December 30. He expressed concern over being unfairly targeted, claiming that the accusations against him are more intense than those directed at his party leader, Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy.

Nani's statement comes amid growing scrutiny and legal battles, adding a new dimension to the political tensions in the state. He urged the public to await the legal outcomes before drawing conclusions.

DY CM Inspects Galiveedu MPDO Office

Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan took a firm stance against alleged attacks on government officials by YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) leaders, warning that such behavior would no longer be tolerated. He was addressing the media after inspecting the MPDO office in Galiveedu village, where MPDO Jawahar Babu was reportedly attacked and severely injured by YSRCP leader Sudarshan Reddy. Pawan Kalyan first visited Kadapa RIMS Hospital, where Jawahar Babu is undergoing treatment, and assured the injured official of the government's support. Later, during his visit to Galiveedu, he interacted with the staff at the MPDO office, offering them courage and affirming that the government would stand by them.

Speaking to the media, Pawan Kalyan issued a strong warning to YSRCP leaders:

"If anyone dares to oppress government officials or acts with arrogance, they will face severe consequences. I am speaking carefully because I am in power, but do not test my patience."

He criticized the YSRCP's behavior,

TTD Announces Key Decision on Recommendation Letters for VIP Break Darshans

Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) has made an important announcement regarding Vaikuntha Dwara Darshans. TTD Executive Officer (EO) Shyamala Rao stated that no recommendation letters will be accepted for VIP break darshans for ten days, from January 10 to 19, during the Vaikuntha Dwara Darshan period. Only protocol dignitaries who attend in person will be accommodated for break darshans during this time.

This decision, according to the EO, has been taken to prioritize the access of common devotees during the Vaikuntha Dwara Darshans. Addressing devotees in the Dial Your TTD EO program, EO Shyamala Rao emphasized that arrangements for Vaikuntha Ekadashi have been carefully planned to ensure smooth operations.

He revealed that 1.40 lakh special entry darshan tickets, priced at Rs. 300 each, have been released for the Vaikuntha Dwara Darshans. These darshans will be conducted over a ten-day period, offering devotees an opportunity to experience the divine blessings during this auspicious time.



In addition, the EO announced that wards the elderly and women. He room allotments to donors will be suspended from January 8 to 19, to better accommodate the surge in devotees. The Koil Alwar Thirumanjanam ritual is scheduled for January 7, marking the preparations for Vaikuntha Ekadashi.


CM Chandrababu Approves Key Proposals to Strengthen Medical and Health Services

In a significant move to enhance health-care services in Andhra Pradesh, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu conducted a detailed review of the state's medical and health department on saturday. - Integrated Call Center: The proposal to manage 108, 104, and NTR insurance scheme services through a unified call center was given the green signal, aiming for streamlined communication and service delivery.
- Health Cards and Preventive Care: Chandrababu emphasized the need for preventive healthcare. He suggested introducing health cards for citizens by conducting comprehensive medical tests, including blood tests, through 104 ambulances as a pilot project.
- AI in Healthcare: The CM called for leveraging AI technology to provide remote medical assistance, enabling patients to access care without visiting hospitals.

Vision for Healthcare:

Chandrababu reiterated his commitment to delivering quality and affordable healthcare to all citizens. He emphasized that these measures, combined with technology and preventive care, would transform the state's medical sector and ensure equitable access to health services.

Minister Narayana Takes Decisive Steps for Amaravati Development

Speaking at the launch of the 2025 diary under the auspices of NEREDCO, the Minister highlighted his commitment to reviving Amaravati's growth. The event was attended by MP Kesineni Shivanath Chinni, MLAS Bonda Umamaheswara Rao and Yarlagadda Venkat Rao, along with representatives from NEREDCO.

The Minister revealed that committees have been formed to address challenges in town planning and ensure timely completion of development projects. He announced that new policies addressing real estate and construction issues, including cellar regulations, would be unveiled by the end of the month. Highlighting the inefficiencies in the current approval process, he noted plans to implement a single-window clearance system and transition all departmental permissions to an online platform by February.

Narayana expressed frustration with the previous government, accusing YSRCP leader YS Jagan Mohan Reddy of disrupting Amaravati's progress with the three-capitals proposal. He criticized the abandonment of projects worth Rs. 60,000 crore initiated under the earlier administration, which caused significant setbacks to the region's growth.

The Minister outlined ambitious plans to construct official buildings, towers, and wide roads to revive Amaravati's real estate sector and boost the state's overall development. He projected substantial progress within a year and urged stakeholders to actively participate in Amaravati's transformation, expressing confidence that these efforts would ensure the capital's role as a cornerstone of Andhra Pradesh's prosperity.



Minister Nadendla Manohar Clarifies Stance on Civil Supplies Irregularities

State Food and Civil Supplies Minister Shri Nadendla Manohar reaffirmed the coalition government's commitment to accountability, stating that no action will be taken to gain favor, nor will wrongdoers be spared. Addressing the media during a program to present insurance checks to families of Jana Sena Party members who lost their lives in accidents, the Minister discussed irregularities in the Civil Supplies Department during the previous YSRCP government.

He asserted that the coalition government operates without political bias and dismissed claims of conspiracies against former minister Perni Nani. "We have no personal vendetta or political bias. Institutions must not be misused for personal gain or to increase family wealth," he emphasized.

Highlighting the anarchy during YSRCP's tenure, he detailed a review of state godowns conducted in November. Discrepancies were uncovered, leading to action against individuals linked to irregularities. Referring to Mrs. Jayasudha's admission of mistakes in writing, the Minister noted that the Civil Supplies Department initiated a Rs. 72 crore penalty and criminal proceedings.

Nadendla Manohar questioned why Perni Nani leased a godown in his wife's name rather than his own, implying an intent to misuse power for financial benefit. "Cases will be registered against those whose names are on the leases. The rice that disappeared from the godowns must be accounted for. If it isn't, the responsible parties will face penalties and criminal charges," he warned.

The Minister assured that the investigation would be impartial and thorough, emphasizing that the coalition government aims to restore good governance under the leadership of Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan. He called on Perni Nani to apologize to the public and cooperate fully with the ongoing inquiry, reiterating that no individual involved in malpractice would go unpunished.



AP Govt Announces Major Welfare Schemes for Women and Youth

The Andhra Pradesh coalition government has unveiled ambitious initiatives aimed at development and welfare, fulfilling its election promises and addressing the needs of women and BC (Backward Classes) communities. Within six months of taking office, the government has revived industries, increased social pensions, reopened Anna canteens, and delivered on promises like three free gas cylinders annually. Now, the government is preparing to launch additional schemes to further empower women and unemployed youth. A major initiative will see 80,000 BC women across the state benefit from free tailoring training as part of a self-employment program. Women who complete 90 days of training will receive sewing machines worth Rs. 24,000 each, enabling them to start their own businesses. Preparations are underway to invite applications through the OBMS portal, with skill development agreements already finalized.

In a move to support unemployed youth, the government is facilitating the establishment of generic medicine shops across towns, cities, and mandals in the state. BC youth with qualifications in B Pharmacy or M Pharmacy will be eligible for loans up to Rs. 8 lakh, with Rs. 4 lakh provided as a subsidy. These shops will not only promote the use of affordable generic medicines but also provide self-employment opportunities to the youth.

PK & Robbin Sharma For TDP's Revival In TG But Why?

The Telugu Desam Party (TDP) currently holds a dominant position in Andhra Pradesh, having decisively triumphed over the YSR Congress in recent elections. With its victory in the state, the party's revival seems unlikely anytime soon for the opposition. However, Chandrababu Naidu is now turning his attention to rejuvenating the party's presence in Telangana. Sources reveal that Prashant Kishor and Robbin Sharma's political strategy firm, Showtime, has presented an extensive plan for this revival to Naidu and Nara Lokesh.

The first phase of this plan will be launched in Mahbubnagar, marking the initial step in re-establishing the party's foothold in Telangana. Naidu is confident that the next Telangana Assembly Elections will be a tightly contested three-way battle, where TDP's support could prove pivotal. Strengthening TDP in both Telugu states is seen as a key move, especially with the potential for a hung verdict in the upcoming General Elections. Although reviving the party in Telangana is a challenging task, even a small gain in the region could be significant. With TDP firmly in control of Andhra Pradesh, Naidu feels he can afford to experiment with his party's prospects in Telangana. The upcoming GHMC elections in 2025 are expected to serve as a crucial test for TDP's resurgence. In the previous election, TDP's traditional supporters shifted their allegiance to Congress, largely due to their admiration for Revanth Reddy.

Additionally, the 'Telangana Sentiment' factor seems to have faded in 2023 following BRS's defeat. Voters in the state appear to have focused on other issues rather than the sentiment that once dominated the political landscape. This shift in priorities could provide TDP with a unique opportunity to test the waters and make a calculated entry, as Naidu sees it.

No Such Thing as Digital Arrest, Warns AP DGP Dwaraka Tirumala Rao

Andhra Pradesh Director General of Police (DGP) Dwaraka Tirumala Rao has cautioned the public against falling prey to cyber fraudsters threatening individuals under the guise of "digital arrest." Addressing the media, he clarified that no legal framework exists for digital arrest and urged people to disregard such claims.

Highlighting the alarming rise in cyber crimes, the DGP disclosed that 916 cases of cyber fraud were registered in 2024, with fraudsters embezzling approximately Rs. 1,229 crore. To combat this surge, cyber crime police stations will be established in every district of Andhra Pradesh.

The DGP also revealed that 572 cases have been filed for posting objectionable content on social media, with "cyber sheets" to be opened against offend-

ers, modeled after traditional "rowdy sheets."

Efforts are underway to strengthen public safety, with plans to connect 1 lakh CCTV cameras to the Command Control Office by March 31. Currently, 25,000 cameras are operational. The state has also introduced the "Eagle" system to address drug-related cases, particularly focusing on encouraging tribal communities to transition from ganja cultivation to alternative crops.

In a pioneering move, Andhra Pradesh has launched "Smart Police AI," a technology aimed at enhancing efficiency in crime registration, case investigation, and traffic management. The Eluru district police are leading this initiative, with Vijayawada set to benefit from AI-driven traffic and congestion control systems. The DGP also confirmed an ongoing investigation into the infiltration of a fake IPS officer into Deputy CM Pawan Kalyan's security team.





MLA Gorantla Butchaiah Chowdary Warns to YCP Leaders

Investigation Into Land Grabbing Under Jagan's Rule

MLA Gorantla Butchaiah Chowdary has issued a stern warning, alleging that widespread land grabbing occurred under YSRCP chief Jagan Mohan Reddy's rule. He announced that the coalition government would initiate a thorough investigation into these irregularities.

Speaking to the media in Rajahmundry on Saturday, Chowdary accused Jagan of weakening key systems and running the state like a dictator. "Jagan has done no significant development work in the past five years. His wrong policies have led to electricity charges skyrocketing and the closure of industries," he said.

The MLA claimed that electricity production decreased due to the purchase of substandard coal, forcing the government to buy power at exorbitant prices. He also alleged that YSRCP leaders purchased transformers at inflated rates, adding to the fi-

nancial burden on the people. "It is shameful for YSRCP leaders to hold dharnas over electricity charges when their policies caused the crisis," Chowdary remarked. Highlighting the coalition government's achievements, he noted that increased pensions were provided immediately after it came to power, and job recruitment began within six months. He assured the public that electricity charges would be reduced in the coming days. Chowdary also accused Jagan of accepting bribes in solar power projects and vowed to investigate all allega-



tions of land grabbing during his tenure. "The people gave the coalition leaders a massive mandate because they were fed up with the YSRCP's irregularities," he said, emphasizing the public's trust in the new govern-

MLA Somireddy Chandramohan Reddy Vows to Expose Land Scams Under YSRCP Rule

Sarvepalli MLA Somireddy Chandramohan Reddy has alleged massive irregularities in land management during the YSRCP government, resulting in a loss of hundreds of crores of rupees. During his visit to Muthukur on Saturday, Somireddy addressed the media, vowing to expose the corruption in assigned lands, benami pattas, and DKT lands under Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy's rule.

Somireddy accused the YS-RCP government of turning Andhra Pradesh into a "hotbed of corruption" through the misuse of the Land Titling Act. "The act has facilitated large-scale irregularities, including the misuse of survey stones that even featured Jagan's image," he said.



Highlighting the actions of the previous TDP government, Somireddy stated that the Land Titling Act was repealed when Chandrababu Naidu was in power, signaling a commitment to transparency and accountability. He alleged that the land scam extended to his constituency, Sarvepalli, and was executed on a grand scale. "We will expose every irregularity committed under the guise of land policies. Those responsible will face the consequences and go to jail," he warned. The MLA's remarks reflect the intensifying scrutiny of the YSRCP's governance, particularly in land management. MLA Daggubati Venkateswara Prasad Slams YSRCP Over Electricity Charges

Anantapur Urban MLA Daggubati Venkateswara Prasad has criticized the YSRCP, accusing it of misleading the public and burdening them with skyrocketing electricity charges. Speaking to the media at his office in Anantapur city, the MLA urged the ruling party to stop its "dramas" and address the real issues.

Daggubati suggested that YSRCP leaders should stage protests at Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy's residence rather than on the streets. "If the real facts come to light, people will criticize you even more," he

The MLA accused Jagan of engaging in fraudulent activities and dismantling state systems since coming to power in 2019. "The root cause of the electricity charge hikes lies with Jagan's corrupt policies," he said, adding that the burden on the people of Andhra Pradesh due to his corruption amounts to ₹1.29 lakh crore.

Recalling the TDP government's achievements, Daggubati pointed out that when Chandrababu Naidu assumed office in 2014, there was a deficit of 22.5 million units of electricity. However, by the time the TDP left power in 2019, the state had a surplus of electricity. "To-



day, under Jagan's rule, the state faces a power shortage due to corruption and nepotism," he alleged.

He further revealed that electricity tariffs have been raised ten times in the past five years, directly burdening the people with ₹32,000 crore. Daggubati criticized the YSRCP for orchestrating "war dramas" and misleading the public with deceitful claims.

"People are observing everything, and no one is willing to believe the lies of YSRCP leaders anymore," he remarked, expressing confidence that the truth will

Botsa Satyanarayana Slams Film Celebrities and Criticizes Political **Hypocrisy**

YSRCP Opposition leader in the council and former minister Botsa Satyanarayana has made sharp remarks regarding film celebrities and political leaders, questioning their actions and motives in recent events.

Botsa criticized AP Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, questioning why he is silent on the government's alleged wrongdoings despite previously claiming he would act against them. Referring to an incident involving a fake IPS officer during Pawan Kalyan's tour, Botsa questioned the handling of the situation and mocked the police for taking photos with the impostor. He also accused the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) of fabricating allegations against Minister Kondapalli Srinivas. "TDP leaders create controversies where none exist. Minister Srinivas is my political opponent who won against my brother, but baseless cam-



paigns against him are unacceptable," he said.

Turning his attention to AP DGP Dwaraka Tirumala Rao, Botsa criticized his leadership, alleging that the DGP is hesitant to take firm actions and even reluctant to answer calls. "The DGP seems to have forgotten his role after assuming office," he said.

On Jamili elections, Botsa clarified that Chandrababu Naidu had spoken about them in the past, but the YSRCP has never addressed the topic. He also criticized BJP AP President Purandeshwari for her inconsistent statements, accusing her of diverting attention from pressing issues.

Botsa's comments have sparked fresh debates, reflecting the ongoing tensions between political and cinematic personalities in Andhra Pradesh.

A BJP delegation has called for an in-depth investigation into the Tirumala Parakamani case, alleging misappropriation of over ₹100 crore and accusing officials of negligence and corruption. The delegation, including BJP leaders Pathuri Nagabhushanam, Tirupati Governing Council member Bhanu

Prakash Reddy, and Minority Morcha State President Sheikh Baji, met Andhra Pradesh DGP Dwaraka Tirumala Rao on Saturday to submit a petition demanding action.

Addressing the media after the meeting, Bhanu Prakash Reddy raised questions about a police officer who allegedly pressured the TTD (Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams) during the previous government to compromise on the case. He alleged that Ravi Kumar, a clerk-level employee, was caught stealing from Parakamani but managed to amass crores of rupees in assets, raising suspicions of collusion. Reddy accused certain board members and officials of shielding Ravi Kumar instead of recovering the looted money. "Some land thieves even conspired to claim shares in the loot. There are new RRRs involved, and their names



will be exposed soon," he warned. He criticized the YSRCP government for turning the police and administrative services into tools for their political agenda, claiming that temples are being looted under their rule. Reddy expressed anger over the negligence of the previous government in addressing this issue, demanding accountability for all involved.

The BJP leader assured that the current TTD EO Vigilance has already initiated a probe into the matter. "Those who have stolen the property of the Swami will face punishment," Reddy asserted.

The Tirumala Parakamani case continues to spark outrage, with the BJP intensifying its calls for transparency and justice in safeguarding temple funds and assets.

Elder Son and Daughter-in-Law Arrested for Mother's Murder Over Gold

In a shocking incident, the elder son and daughter-in-law of a 62-year-old woman have been arrested for her murder after they allegedly killed her for her gold ornaments. The crime, which took place in the Madhuranagar area under Gunadala Police Station, was exposed following a complaint lodged by the deceased's younger son.

On the morning of December 26, 2024, the complainant, residing in Devinagar, reported to Gunadala Police Station that his mother,

Maa Lakshmi, was found dead in her home. However, upon inspection, it was discovered that the gold ornaments which she had been wearing were missing. Suspecting foul play, the complainant raised doubts, leading to the registration of a case under Crime No. 209/2024, section 194 BNSS.

The investigation was swiftly launched under the supervision of City Police Commissioner Sri S.V. Rajasekhara Babu IPS and DCP Sri Gautami Shali IPS. Gunadala Inspector Vasireddy Srinivas, with the assistance of SI Rakhib and their team, began questioning local residents. It was revealed that the elder son, Sambasivarao, along with his wife Vani, had visited his mother the night of the incident and had an argument over property. They did not attend the funeral, which further aroused suspicion. On December 27, 2024, acting on specific intelligence, the police apprehended the accused at Vijayawada Railway Station. The couple, identified as Sambasivarao (43) and Vani (35), both from Mangalagiri in Guntur district, were arrested after the stolen gold worth approximately 4 lakh rupees was recovered from

During the interrogation, it was revealed that Sambasivarao, who had been facing financial difficulties after a paralysis diagnosis, demanded his share of the family property and money from his mother. When she refused, he, along with his wife, decided to kill her. On the night of December 25, Sambasivarao suffocated his mother with a pillow while his wife held her legs. After confirming her death, they stole the gold ornaments and fled the scene.

The police acted swiftly after receiving information from the younger son of the deceased. Fearful of being caught, the couple attempted to flee to Hyderabad, but were arrested before they could leave the city.

Police Commissioner Sri S.V. Rajasekhara Babu IPS congratulated the Gunadala Police team for solving the case in just two days and recovering the stolen property.

Central ACP Sri Damodar, Gunadala Inspector Vasireddy Srinivas, SI Rakhib, and their staff were instrumental in cracking this case.

Encroachments and Illegal Dwakra Bazaar Operations at Swarajya Maidan in Vijayawada

TPN Correspondent Vijayawada, Dec 29

Devaki Devi has come under scrutiny for running a



Dwakra Bazaar without government permission at Swarajya Maidan, a prominent location where a 125-foot statue of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was installed by the previous government. Devaki Devi is reportedly operating this market illegally, allegedly exploiting Dwakra women by charging them for stalls at the event.

The Dwakra Bazaar, which is running for 55 days, has approximately 150 stalls, with 50 stalls allocated to local Dwakra women and the remaining 100 stalls set up by individuals from outside the state. According to reports, local women are charged Rs. 1,000 per stall per day, while outsiders are charged Rs. 2,000 per stall per day. It is claimed that around Rs. 85 lakh will be collected from the Dwakra women alone during the 55-day event, with an additional Rs. 15 lakh reportedly collected from canteen operators, totaling nearly Rs. 1 crore. These funds are allegedly being deposited into Devaki Devi's account.

Despite the massive sums involved, there is no official approval for this event. The Abhyudaya Dwakra State Committee, under whose banner this bazaar is being run,



has not provided any evidence of government authorization. There are also concerns about safety hazards, as the Dwakra Bazaar lacks fire safety measures or precautionary plans for accidents.

Moreover, Devaki Devi has claimed close ties with CM Chandrababu Naidu, showing photographs to suggest that the CM is a personal acquaintance, which she uses to justify the operation of the bazaar. She has reportedly been using her influence to bypass authorities, stating that she and others in her circle can force government officials, including collectors, to comply with their demands.

The Swarajya Maidan, which was handed over to the Social Welfare Department under the previous government for the installation of the Ambedkar statue, is meant to remain free of any construction. Despite this, Devaki Devi's encroachments have raised serious concerns regarding illegal activity and potential corruption associated with the operation of the Dwakra Bazaar.

As the controversy surrounding the illegal market continues, questions are being raised about the involvement of government officials and the accountability of those operating the bazaar.

Homelessness in the U.S. **Hits Alarming Record**

The homelessness crisis in the United States has reached an unprecedented scale, resembling a storm growing silently over the ocean before crashing onto shore with devastating force. According to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) latest report, a staggering 771,480 people were homeless on a single night in January 2024. This marks the highest figure ever recorded and reflects an 18.1% surge compared to the

This sharp increase sheds light on longstanding systemic issues, including stagnant wages, skyrocketing housing costs, and the lingering impacts of natural disasters. HUD's findings underscore the intersection of economic instability, housing shortages, and climate crises, which together create a perfect storm for those already teetering on the edge of financial security.

The crisis has been especially acute in states like Illinois and Hawaii. Illinois reported a jaw-dropping 116.2% rise in homelessness, primarily driven by an influx of migrants seeking shelter in cities like Chicago. Meanwhile, Hawaii faced an 87% increase in its homeless population due to devastating wildfires that displaced hundreds last year. These statistics highlight the interconnected nature of homelessness, where factors such as economic uncertainty, environmental disasters, and insufficient affordable housing exacerbate an already dire situation.

Adrianne Todman, HUD's Deputy Secretary, has emphasized that "no American should endure homelessness," yet the statistics paint millions vulnerable to the harsh realities of a grim picture. Children and families are life without stable shelter? The stakes have bearing the brunt of this crisis, with nearly never been higher, and the nation's response 150,000 children reported homeless—a 33% will define its commitment to addressing one increase from 2023. Family homelessness also of the most pressing humanitarian issues of surged by 40%, driven by mounting financial

pressures and unaffordable rent hikes.

The data also reveal stark racial disparities. Black Americans, who make up just 12% of the U.S. population, account for 32% of the homeless population. This alarming disparity underscores the persistent impact of structural racism on housing insecurity, highlighting the urgent need for targeted policies to address racial inequities and promote housing stability.

The homelessness crisis extends beyond mere numbers; it is a humanitarian catastrophe that threatens to reshape the social fabric of the nation. Without significant policy interventions and increased investments in affordable housing, homelessness risks becoming a permanent feature of American life. Measures such as rent control, increased wages, and robust social safety nets could play a pivotal role in reversing the current trajectory.

The situation calls for immediate action to prevent further escalation. Policymakers must prioritize funding for affordable housing projects, expand emergency shelters, and implement programs that address the root causes of homelessness, such as income inequality and inadequate access to mental health services.

As the crisis deepens, its ripple effects could lead to greater social instability and economic strain across communities. The time to act is now. The question remains: will the U.S. rise to meet this challenge, or will homelessness continue to grow unchecked, leaving our time.

"Fewer Re-Runs Of Friends, More Books": Vivek Ramaswamy On H1B Row

Vivek Ramaswamy, the entrepreneur and former Republican presidential candidate, has weighed in on the ongoing debate over immigration and hiring trends in the U.S. tech sector. His comments, posted on X (formerly Twitter), came amid growing discussions about Indian immigrants' success in the United States and the cultural implications of the H1B visa program. Ramaswamy, who is set to lead the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE) alongside Elon Musk in the upcoming Donald Trump administration, called for a cultural shift in the U.S. to prioritize excellence, achievement, and hard work over mediocrity.

Ramaswamy, a first-generation U.S. citizen whose parents immigrated from India, argued that the reason many top tech companies hire foreign-born and first-generation engineers is not due to an innate IQ advantage, but a cultural difference. He rejected the idea that these workers are chosen because they are inherently smarter than native-born Americans. Instead, Ramaswamy suggested that it is American culture that needs to change to ensure global competitiveness.

He highlighted a shift in American culture that began in the 1990s, which, according to him, has been more focused on social conformity and popularity than on academic and intellectual excellence. Ramaswamy claimed that American society began to value normalcy and mediocrity over achievement, a trend that is reflected in popular media and school systems. He criticized shows like Boy Meets World, Saved by the Bell, and Family Matters for portraying characters who prioritized social status over intellectual pursuits.

In contrast, Ramaswamy pointed out that immigrant parents, particularly those from India, often place greater emphasis on academic success, particularly in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields.



He described how many immigrant parents actively discouraged their children from watching television shows that promoted what he termed "mediocrity," encouraging them instead to focus on their studies and participate in extracurricular academic activities.

To support his argument, Ramaswamy proposed a cultural shift in the U.S. that would prioritize "achievement over normalcy, excellence over mediocrity, nerdiness over conformity, and hard work over laziness." He suggested that American youth should focus more on activities like math tutoring, weekend science competitions, and reading books, and less on social activities like sleepovers, Saturday morning cartoons, and hanging out at the mall. He emphasized that

this cultural shift is necessary if the U.S. wants to remain competitive in a hyper-competitive global market for technical talent.

Ramaswamy acknowledged that such an approach is often met with skepticism in American society. Many American parents view the intense focus on academics as extreme, and children who excel in STEM fields are often seen as "nerds" or outliers. However, Ramaswamy argued that this mindset is counterproductive in the global competition for top talent. He warned that if the U.S. continues to venerate mediocrity over excellence, it risks falling behind countries like China in the race for technological advancement.

He referred to the current moment as America's

"Sputnik moment," drawing a parallel to the Cold War-era launch of the Soviet Union's first satellite, which spurred the U.S. to accelerate its space program. Ramaswamy expressed hope that the election of Donald Trump could mark the beginning of a new era in America, but only if the country undergoes a cultural awakening to prioritize achievement and excellence.

Ramaswamy's call for cultural change comes amid broader discussions about the H1B visa program, which allows U.S. companies to hire foreign workers, particularly in the tech industry. Critics argue that the program displaces American workers, while supporters, including Ramaswamy, suggest that it helps bring in top talent from around the world, which is essential for maintaining U.S. global leadership in in-

Ramaswamy concluded by urging Americans to stop focusing on victimhood or legislating alternative hiring practices, and instead to address the cultural issues that are hindering the country's ability to compete on a global stage. He expressed confidence that the U.S. can make this cultural shift and become a global leader in innovation once again.

In a related note, Canadian musician Grimes, Elon Musk's former partner, also addressed the rising anti-India sentiment on social media. She defended Indian culture, recalling her own experiences growing up in a half-Indian household, and emphasized that Indian culture blends well with Western values.

Ramaswamy's comments have sparked a significant conversation about how U.S. culture can evolve to foster a competitive, achievement-driven society in the face of global challenges. Whether this shift will take place remains to be seen, but it underscores the ongoing debate over immigration, hiring practices, and the future of America's global standing in the tech industry.





Last Rites Held With State Honours, Nation Pays Tribute

Former Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh, regarded as the "architect of India's economic reforms," was laid to rest with full state honours on Saturday at Nigambodh Ghat in Delhi. Dr. Singh, who served two terms as Prime Minister from 2004 to 2014 in the Congress-led UPA government, passed away at the age of 92 due to age-related complications.

The funeral was attended by a host of political dignitaries, including President Droupadi Murmu, Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar, Prime Achievements Minister Narendra Modi, Bhutan's Prime Minister Tshering Tobgay, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge, and members of the Gandhi family, including Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi.

The Centre declared a seven-day state mourning in honour of Dr. Singh, during which the national flag will fly at half-mast across the country. The Congress party also announced the cancellation of its official programs, including its Foundation Day celebration, for the next seven days. These activities will resume on January 3.

Political Dispute Over Memorial Site

A political dispute erupted between the Centre and the Congress over the location for Dr. Singh's memorial. The Congress party expressed disappointment with the selection of Nigambodh Ghat for the last rites, arguing that it was not suitable for a memorial. Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge wrote to Prime Minister Modi, requesting that the location of the final rites be preserved for a memorial, as is customary for former leaders and Prime Ministers.

In response, BJP spokesperson CR Kesavan criticized the Congress for its stance, calling it "ironic" given that the Congress-led UPA government had not built a memorial for former Prime Minister Narasimha Rao, who passed away in 2004.

The Centre, however, clarified that it would allocate a suitable space for Dr. Singh's memorial and had already communicated this to Kharge and Dr. Singh's family.

Farewell to Manmohan Singh

Sharmistha Mukherjee, daughter of the late former President Pranab Mukherjee, also criticized Kharge's request. In a statement on X, she pointed out that when her father passed away in 2020, the Congress leadership did not even convene a condolence meeting, let alone discuss a memorial for him.

A Legacy of Reforms and

Dr. Singh's death marks the end of an era in Indian politics. Born in 1932, he was a distinguished economist and served in various key positions before becoming Prime Minister, including as





the Finance Minister during the 1991 economic reforms. He held degrees from the University of Cambridge and Nuffield College, Oxford. Dr. Singh was awarded the Padma Vibhushan, India's second-highest civilian award, in 1987.

Dr. Singh's leadership during his tenure as

All-Woman Team To Investigate Anna University Rape

Survivor To Receive Rs 25 **Lakh Compensation**

The Madras High Court has directed the formation of a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to probe the recent alleged sexual assault of a woman student at Anna University in Chennai. The SIT will consist of three women IPS officers, ensuring a sensitive and thorough investigation.

The court also ordered the state government to provide the victim with a compensation of Rs 25 lakh. This ruling came during the hearing of a plea seeking to transfer the investigation to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

In addition, the bench, comprising Justice S. M. Subramaniam and Justice V. Lakshminarayan, emphasized that the survivor's education should not be disrupted by the traumatic event. The court instructed Anna University not to charge any fees from her during this period.

The incident, which has sparked widespread outrage from opposition parties and civil society, led to one arrest so far. The court's intervention aims to ensure justice for the victim and uphold her rights throughout the investigation.

Row Over AAP's Free Schemes After Lt Governor Orders Investigation

Delhi Lt Governor VK Saxena has ordered investigations into allegations surrounding the Aam Aadmi Party's (AAP) welfare schemes ahead of the upcoming assembly elections. The orders follow complaints raised by Congress leader Sandeep Dikshit, prompting separate directives to the Delhi Chief Secretary and the Commissioner of Police.

personal data collection under AAP's Mahila Samman Yojana, the presence of Punjab intelligence officers near Congress candidates' residences, and the transfer of cash from Punjab to Delhi to influence the elections.

In his complaint to the Lt Governor, Mr. Dikshit alleged that cash was being transported from Punjab to Delhi to fund election-related activities. In response, the Lt Governor's office has instructed the Delhi Police to monitor vehicles entering the city from neighboring states and has alerted police forces in Punjab, Harvana, and Rajasthan to prevent any illegal activity.



The allegations include claims of fraudulent Dikshit's complaint also raised concerns about the Mahila Samman Yojana, a scheme offering Rs 2,100 per month to eligible women. The Lt Governor has tasked the Chief Secretary with conducting an inquiry into claims that private individuals were illegally collecting personal data under the pretext of enrolling beneficiaries. The Delhi Police has been directed to take legal action against those organizing unauthorized registration camps.

In response, AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal dismissed the allegations as "fake." He criticized the BJP, claiming that if they win the elections, they will cancel the Mahila Samman Yojana,

Sanjeevani Yojana, free electricity, free education, and other benefits.

Earlier, the Delhi government's Women and Child Development and Health departments issued public notices clarifying that the Mahila Samman Yojana and the Sanjeevani Yojana were not government-approved schemes and warned citizens against sharing personal details with unauthorized individuals, labeling the registrations as fraudulent.

In another serious accusation, Dikshit alleged that Punjab intelligence officers were stationed near Congress candidates' homes in Delhi. The Lt Governor's office has instructed the Delhi Police Commissioner to investigate this claim and submit a report within three days.

AAP has claimed the investigations are politically motivated, accusing the BJP of using the Lt Governor's office to undermine its election campaign. The party has also alleged that the BJP's opposition to the Mahila Samman Yojana reflects its lack of respect for women. AAP further emphasized that over 22 lakh women have already registered for the scheme, showing widespread public support.

Manipur CM Condemns Indiscriminate Firing by Kuki Militants; Two Injured

Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh strongly condemned the "indiscriminate firing" by Kuki militants on two villages in Imphal East district on Friday, which resulted in the injury of a policeman and a civilian. The attack, which originated from the hills, targeted the villages of Sanasabi and Thamnapokpi, causing widespread panic in the area.

In a post on X (formerly Twitter), the

Chief Minister expressed his outrage, calling the attack a "cowardly and unprovoked assault on innocent lives." He emphasized that the attack undermined peace and harmony, and called on both central forces and state police to coordinate effectively in such situations.

"Strongly condemn the indiscriminate firing by Kuki militants at Sanasabi and Thamnapokpi in Imphal East, which injured civilians and security personnel. This cowardly and unprovoked attack on innocent lives is an assault on peace and harmony," the Chief Minister said. He further assured that adequate security personnel had been dispatched to the affected areas and that the injured were receiving medical assistance. Singh appealed for calm and unity in the face of such challenges. The two targeted villages are located at the foothills of the region. Disturbing visuals from the area showed people from the Meitei community, including elderly women and children, fleeing the violence as automatic gunfire echoed in the background.

5,000 Tourists Rescued in Himachal's Kullu Amid Heavy Snowfall

Around 5,000 tourists stranded in Solang Nala, a popular ski resort in Himachal Pradesh's Kullu, were rescued on Friday following heavy snowfall in the region. The Kullu police launched a rescue operation on December 27 after approximately 1,000 vehicles, carrying tourists and other travelers, became stuck due to the snow. "Due to fresh snowfall on December 27, about

1,000 vehicles, including those carrying around 5,000 tourists, were stranded in Solang Nala. Kullu Police successfully rescued the tourists and transported them to safe locations. The rescue operation is ongoing," the Kullu police stated in a post on X.

The ongoing snowfall has caused widespread disruptions across the state, with the India Meteorological Department (IMD) issuing an orange alert for heavy snowfall and cold waves on December 27 and 28. Himachal Pradesh has been experiencing intense weather conditions, particularly in the districts of Lahaul-Spiti, Chamba, Kangra, Kullu, Shimla, and Kinnaur. The IMD forecasted that from December 29 onwards, a renewed cold wave will affect the plains, including Bilaspur, Hamirpur, and Una districts. Mandi, Kullu, and Chamba are also expected to face severe cold conditions until January 1. Dense fog is predicted for isolated areas on January 1, further complicating travel with reduced visibility.


Bhutan Holds Special Prayers for Manmohan Singh, King Attends Funeral in Delhi

Bhutan paid tribute to former Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh with special prayers and ceremonies on Saturday, following his passing. King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck led the nation in honoring Dr. Singh, attending his funeral in Delhi, a day after offering prayers at a Buddhist monastery in Thimphu.

Separate prayer ceremonies were held across all 20 Dzongkhags (districts) of Bhutan in his memory, the Bhutan government confirmed. The royal family, along with senior government officials, participated in the ceremonies, which included lighting a thousand butter lamps at Thimphu's Kuenrey of Tashichhodzong, led by the King. Prime Minister Tshering Tobgay, Indian Ambassador Sudhakar Dalela, and members of the Bhutanese royal family were also pres-

As a mark of respect, Bhutan's national flag was flown at half-mast throughout the country and at its embassies and consulates worldwide. "As a mark of respect to the late former prime minister and in solidarity with the government and people of India, all national flags across the country and at Bhutan's embassies, missions, and consulates abroad are being flown at half-mast," the Bhutanese government stated.

On Saturday, King Wangchuck attended



Dr. Singh's funeral at Nigambodh Ghat in Delhi, paying his respects in person. Dr. Singh, who served as India's prime minister from 2004 to 2014, was widely regarded as the architect of India's economic reforms. He passed away on Thursday at the age of 92 at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS).

Under Dr. Singh's leadership, India-Bhutan relations flourished, particularly in the areas of trade and hydro-power cooperation. Suchir Balaji, a former researcher at OpenAI, was found dead in his San Francisco apartment last month. Known for his criticism of the company. Balaii had accused OpenAI of violating copyright laws, particularly in its use of internet-sourced data to train its AI models. His tragic death came just a month after he publicly shared his

In an interview with Business Insider, Balaji's mother, Poornima Ramarao, spoke about her son's growing disillusionment with OpenAI and the factors that led to his decision to leave the company. She revealed that Balaji believed OpenAI had deviated from its original mission, moving away from being a nonprofit, open-source initiative to a more commercially-driven organization. His concerns deepened as OpenAI launched ChatGPT, a product built with the data he had contributed to for GPT-4.

Ramarao said her son felt that artificial intelligence posed a danger to humanity. The ideological clash between his values and OpenAI's corporate direction ultimately led him to resign in August.



Donald Trump Hints at Potential Meeting with Bill Gates in Message to Elon Musk

President-elect Donald Trump has sparked speculation with a recent post on Truth Social, suggesting that Bill Gates may soon meet him at Mar-a-Lago. The post also included a warm reference to Elon Musk's son, X Æ A-Xii, and expressed enthusiasm for an upcoming New Year's Eve celebration.

Reports indicate that Gates has indeed reached out to Trump's transition team to discuss a potential meeting, though details remain unclear. This follows a series of meetings between Trump and various tech CEOs since his November election

Trump's relationships with tech leaders have garnered significant attention, particularly after naming Musk as co-leader of his government efficiency initiative. However, Musk has faced criticism from some Trump supporters due to his backing of a visa program that allows highly skilled foreign workers to immigrate to the U.S.

The meeting between Trump and Gates would not be their first. They initially met in December 2016, before Trump's first presidential term. The attacks, which targeted Krishnan's Indian origin, have been denounced by groups including Indiaspora, emphasizing that there is no place for racial discrimination in public discourse.

In a media advisory issued on Saturday, the Indian-American diaspora expressed its support for Krishnan, condemning the "reprehensible racist attacks" directed at him. "There is absolutely no place in our public discourse for spiteful, vengeful, racially motivated, ad hominem epithets," the statement said. It reiterated the community's strong endorsement of Krishnan's appointment, expressing confidence in his ability to serve the country effectively. Indian-American Congressman Ro Khanna also spoke out against those attacking Krishnan over his Indian heritage. He stressed that the United States' ability to attract talent from around the world is a testament to its "exceptionalism," which sets it apart from countries like China. "It is great that talent around the world wants to come here, not to China, and that Sriram can rise to the highest levels," Khanna wrote on X, referring to the concept of "American exceptionalism."

Krishnan, who was nominated by Trump as Senior Policy Advisor for Artificial Intelligence at the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy, acknowledged the opportunity and expressed his gratitude. Trump announced the appointment on Truth Social, highlighting Krishnan's extensive background in technology and his work with companies like Microsoft, Meta, and X. Krishnan previously served as a General Partner at Andreessen Horowitz and invested in prominent firms like SpaceX and Figma.

Krishnan holds a Bachelor of Technology in Information Technology from SRM Engineering College, Anna University.



Issued Over 1 Million Nonimmigrant Visas To Indians For 2nd Year: US Embassy

The US mission in India announced on Friday that it issued over one million nonimmigrant visas in 2024, marking the second consecutive year of surpassing this milestone. This includes a record number of visitor visas, reflecting the growing demand among Indians for travel to the US for tourism, business, and ed-

In the past four years, the number of Indian visitors to the US has increased fivefold, with over two million Indians traveling to the US in the first 11 months of 2024, a 26% rise from the previous year. The embassy also highlighted the success of a pilot program allowing Indian H-1B visa holders to renew their visas without leaving the US, with plans to formalize this process in 2025.

Additionally, the mission issued tens of thousands of immigrant visas, contributing to family reunification and the migration of skilled professionals. India continues to be the top sender of international students to the US, with over 331,000 students studying there in 2024, marking the highest number since the 2008/2009

Putin Apologizes to Azerbaijan Over Plane Crash in Russian Airspace



an apology to Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev following the tragic crash of an Azerbaijan Airlines passenger plane in Russian airspace on Wednesday. The plane, Flight J2-8243, crashed in a fiery explosion near Aktau in Kazakhstan after diverting from southern Russia, where Ukrainian drone attacks were reported in several cities.

The incident, which resulted in the deaths of at least 38 people, occurred after the plane attempted to land at Grozny Airport in Chechnya. As the aircraft was attempting to land, Ukrainian drones were reportedly attacking cities including Grozny, Mozdok, and Vladikavkaz. Russian air defense systems successfully repelled these attacks, but the plane was forced to divert from its intended route.

Russian President Vladimir Putin has issued In a statement released by the Kremlin on Saturday, President Putin extended his "deep and sincere condolences" to the families of the victims and wished a speedy recovery to the injured passengers. "President Vladimir Putin apologised for the tragic incident that occurred in Russian airspace," the statement read.

India's Forex Reserves Decline by \$8.4 Billion to \$644.3 Billion: RBI

Tndia's foreign exchange re serves have experienced a significant decline, falling by \$8.478 billion to \$644.391 billion for the week ending December 20, 2024, according to data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday. This follows a decrease of \$1.988 billion in the previous week, marking a continued downtrend in the country's forex reserves.

The decline has been attributed to a combination of factors, including the revaluation of reserves and interventions in the foreign exchange market by the RBI to stabilize the rupee amidst market fluctuations. At their peak, India's forex reserves had reached a record high of

\$704.885 billion at the end of September 2024.

For the week ending December 20, foreign currency assets, which form a major component of the reserves, fell by \$6.014 billion, bringing the total to \$556.562 billion. These assets reflect the effect of changes in the value of non-US currencies such as the euro, pound, and yen, which are part of India's forex holdings.

In addition to the drop in foreign currency assets, India's gold reserves decreased by \$2.33 billion to \$65.726 billion



during the same period. The country's Special Drawing Rights (SDRs) were also down by \$112 million, falling to \$17.885 billion. India's reserve position with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) saw a slight decline of \$23 million, bringing it to \$4.217 billion.

The steady reduction in forex reserves comes amid ongoing efforts by the RBI to manage the rupee's volatility and maintain economic stability.

RBI's New UPI Rule Set to Transform Digital Payments in India

Tn a significant move to enhance the digital payment eco-■ system in India, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) recently announced that users of prepaid payment instruments (PPIs) will now be able to use third-party applications for UPI transactions. This shift is expected to greatly improve the flexibility and convenience of digital payments across the country.

To understand the implications of this decision, it's important to first differentiate between two key digital payment systems: Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs).

UPI vs PPIs: What's the Difference?

UPI, which stands for Unified Payments Interface, is a real-time payment system that allows users to send money directly between bank accounts. UPI apps, such as Google Pay, BHIM, and PhonePe, enable seamless bank-to-bank transfers via mobile numbers and QR codes. UPI transactions are instant and linked directly to a user's bank account.

In contrast, Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs) are essentially mobile wallets, like MobiKwik or Paytm, that store prepaid balances which can be used for transactions within the same app or ecosystem. PPIs are not directly linked to bank accounts, meaning users can only transfer funds within the same platform or wallet, restricting interoperability.

This is where the RBI's new rule comes into play. Until now, users of PPIs could only make UPI transactions using the UPI functionality offered by the PPI provider itself. For example, MobiKwik users could only use its own "Pocket UPI" to make transfers, while PhonePe users were restricted to using BHIM for UPI payments. The new rule, however, breaks down this limitation and allows users to link their PPI accounts with third-party UPI apps.



The Impact of the New Rule

Under the new guidelines, which were officially rolled out on December 27, 2024, users of PPIs like MobiKwik and PhonePe will be able to make UPI payments through any third-party UPI application. This means that a MobiKwik user can now make UPI payments using Google Pay or PhonePe, and vice versa. This will enhance the interoperability between various payment systems, offering users greater flexibility in making digital payments. The change follows a statement made by the RBI in April 2024,

which outlined plans to enable interoperability for PPIs through

third-party UPI apps. Prior to this, PPIs were limited to using only

the UPI functionality provided by the respective PPI issuers. The RBI's latest move is seen as a step toward creating a more inclusive and accessible digital payment system.

Benefits for Consumers and the Digital Economy

This development is expected to significantly streamline the digital payment process for users who rely on mobile wallets. By allowing PPIs to integrate with third-party UPI apps, users will now have access to a broader range of payment options, eliminating the need to stick to a single platform. It will also pave the way for easier transfers between different platforms, making it simpler for users to make payments or transfer funds across wallets.

Furthermore, this increased interoperability will help drive the adoption of digital payments across India, especially in semi-urban and rural areas where mobile wallets have a large user base. By providing more payment options and flexibility, the new rule is expected to further empower millions of consumers and boost digital transaction volumes in the country.

The RBI's move is part of a broader push to promote digital financial inclusion and reduce cash dependency in India. It not only benefits users but also strengthens the overall digital infrastructure, positioning India as a leader in digital payments globally. As the country moves towards greater financial digitization, such regulatory changes will continue to shape the future of the payments landscape.





Delhi Records Highest Single-Day December Rainfall in 101 Years

 $\mathbf{D}^{ ext{elhi}}_{ ext{gle-day rainfall in December in over}$ a century, recording 41.2 mm of rain in the 24 hours leading up to 8:30 am on Saturday. This marks the highest December rainfall in 101 years, according to the India Meteorological Department (IMD). The previous record for the highest single-day rainfall in December was set on December 3, 1923, with 75.7 mm of rain.

This downpour also placed December 2024 among the top five wettest months of December in Delhi's history, making it the fifth-highest since records began in 1901. The IMD noted that the 24-hour rainfall total at Safdarjung station was the second-highest on record.

On Saturday, Delhi woke up to an overcast sky, with the IMD forecasting more light to moderate rain throughout the day and issuing a yellow alert. The rainfall is being driven by an active western disturbance interacting with easterly winds, affecting Northwest and Central India, including Delhi-NCR. The minimum temperature on Saturday was recorded at 12.7°C, six degrees above the season's average, providing some relief from the usual winter chill.

In terms of air quality, Delhi saw an improvement, with the



Air Quality Index (AQI) moving into the 'moderate' category. At 9 am on Saturday, the AQI stood at 152, according to data from the Central Pollution Control Board. AQI values between 101 and 200 are classified as 'moderate,' indicating a slight health concern for sensitive individuals.

The unusual weather patterns this December highlight the ongoing shifts in climate, with the IMD continuing to monitor conditions closely.

Gus Atkinson, Saim Ayub, Shamar Joseph, Kamindu Mendis Up for ICC **Men's Emerging Cricketer of the Year**

The nominees for the prestigious ICC Men's Emerging Cricketer of the Year Award 2024 have been announced, with exciting young talents from around the globe in the running. Gus Atkinson (England), Kamindu Mendis (Sri Lanka), Saim Ayub (Pakistan), and Shamar Joseph (West Indies) have all earned nominations for their exceptional performances over the past year.

Gus Atkinson, the English pacer, has made an impressive mark since his debut in July, during James Anderson's final Test. The 26-year-old's stunning performance at Lord's against the West Indies, where he took a career-best 7/45 followed by a five-wicket haul in the second innings, helped him record the fourth-best debut figures in men's Test cricket history. Mendis's career-best knock of 182 against New Zealand played a vital role in Sri Lanka's 2-0 series win and bolstered their World Test Championship campaign. He also impressed with 267 runs in England, contributing to Sri Lanka's first Test victory in England in a decade.

Saim Ayub of Pakistan, aged just 22, has captivated the cricket world with his fearless batting at the top of the order. Ayub's contributions were pivotal in Pakistan's successful series wins against Australia, Zimbabwe, and South Africa. He scored two centuries in South Africa, earning the Player of the Series award in the process. Ayub also impressed with the ball, taking five wickets in ODIs at an economy rate of 4.63. all-round abilities.

Shamar Joseph, the 22-year-old West Indies pacer, has emerged as one of the most promising talents in world cricket. Gutsy Nitish Reddy's Maiden Ton Keeps India Afloat vs Australia

Nitish Reddy, a relatively unknown entity in Test cricket before the Border-Gavaskar series, emerged as India's savior on Day 3 of the Boxing Day Test in Melbourne, playing a gutsy knock that took India to 358/9. His unbeaten 105 not only gave India a fighting chance but also severely dented Australia's hopes of securing an early win. Despite being 116 runs behind Australia's first-innings total of 474, Reddy's dogged century ensured that India remained in the contest, with rain bringing an early end to play.

Reddy's stellar performance was pivotal in India's recovery, especially after the dismissal of Rishabh Pant, whose rash shot left India struggling

at 191/6. The 21-year-old Andhra Pradesh cricketer's innings was a masterclass in resilience. His 127run partnership with Washington Sundar (50 off 162 balls) helped India claw back into the game, shifting the momentum in their favor. The young batter's composure under pressure drew praise from cricket legend Sunil Gavaskar, who hailed it as one of the greatest knocks in Test history, given the circumstances. As Reddy neared his maiden Test century, the tension rose. He could have been stranded on 99 when Jasprit Bumrah was dismissed, leaving Reddy to face the Australian bowlers with last-man Mohammed Siraj at the crease. Despite the pressure, Siraj survived three deliveries, allowing Reddy to bring up his hundred in style.

A picture-perfect straight drive off Scott Boland marked the moment of triumph, and Reddy took a knee, helmet in hand, acknowledging the Indian dug-out, which rose in appreciation. The celebration was pure drama—Reddy struck a 'Pushpa' pose after reaching fifty and later mimicked the 'Bahubali' stance to celebrate his century.

Reddy's father, Muthyala, watching from the stands, was overcome with emotion as his son reached the milestone, reflecting on the family's sacrifices. A decade ago, when Reddy's father took a financial risk to support his son's cricketing dreams, many advised against it, but today, Reddy's performances are proving them right.


