# FORMER PM SINGH'S FUNERAL

Funeral concludes at Delhi's Nigambodh Ghat Funeral according to Sikh traditions Rahul Gandhi carried Manmohan Singh's coffin President, Vice President, Prime Minister attend funeral

TPN, New Delhi: The funeral of former Prime Foreign dignitaries, including Bhutanese King Minister Manmohan Singh concluded with military honors at Nigambodh Ghat in Delhi. The ceremony was conducted according to Sikh traditions, with Congress leader Rahul Gandhi carrying the coffin as a mark of respect.

The solemn event saw the presence of President Draupadi Murmu, Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and several Union Ministers, including Amit Shah, Rajnath Singh, JP Nadda, and Kiren Rijiju. Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla, Congress leaders Sonia Gandhi, Mallikarjun Kharge, Rahul Gandhi, and Priyanka Gandhi, along with Delhi Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena and Delhi Chief Minister Atishi, also attended. Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, BRS Working President K.T. Rama Rao, and the heads of the three armed forces were among the dignitaries present.

Jigme Khesar Wangchuck, joined the funeral to pay their respects to the veteran leader.

Manmohan Singh, aged 92, passed away after suddenly losing consciousness at his residence. He was immediately rushed to AIIMS, where he died during treatment.

Singh served as the Prime Minister of India for two consecutive terms, from 2004 to 2014. Known for his calm demeanor and economic acumen, he previously held key positions as the Governor of the Reserve Bank of India and Union Finance Minister in PV Narasimha Rao's cabinet.

The loss of the seasoned statesman has left the nation mourning, with tributes pouring in from leaders across the political spectrum and abroad.







# **ACB Hands Over Key Evidence** to ED in Formula E Case

ACB Provides Crucial Evidence to ED in Formula E Probe Allegations of Misconduct and Unauthorized Payments Surface **ED** Investigation Intensifies Amid Claims of Rule Violations

**TPN**, **Hyderabad**: In a new twist to the Formula E car racing case, the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) has handed over crucial evidence to the Enforcement Directorate (ED). This includes the FIR, Finance Department records, Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority (HMDA) payment details, and agreement documents.

The ACB also filed a counter in

the High Court, alleging criminal

misconduct and misappropriation

of government funds by Telanga-

na Minister K.T. Rama Rao (KTR).

The counter states that KTR pres-

sured officials to authorize pay-

ments without Cabinet or Finance Department approval. A transfer of ₹55 crore to a foreign company was flagged as unauthorized, along with an additional burden of ₹8 crore on HMDA.

The ACB emphasized that the case was registered only after obtaining due permissions, rejecting claims of political bias or undue influence.



## Nitish Kumar Shines with **Century in Melbourne Test**

TPN, India: Telugu cricketer Nitish Kumar Reddy has made a remarkable mark on Australian soil by scoring a century in the ongoing Melbourne Test, becoming the first Indian batter to score a century at number 8. Reddy completed his century off 171 balls, with 10 fours and one six, leading India through a challenging phase in the match. His remarkable innings helped India avoid the fear of follow-on and possible defeat, with the team's score at 354/9 in the first innings. Despite his efforts, Australia maintains a 120-run lead.

## **Telangana Assembly** to Hold Special Session

TPN, Telangana: The Telangana Legislative Assembly will convene for a special session on the 30th of December, 2024, at 10 am on Monday. During this session, the assembly will observe a period of mourning and pay tribute to the late former Prime Minister, Dr. Manmohan Singh.

Dr. Singh, aged 92, passed away on Thursday night after suffering from age-related health issues. His family rushed him to the hospital after he lost consciousness, but despite efforts to resuscitate him for an hour and a half, he was declared dead at 9:51 am by AIIMS.

In honor of his passing, the central government has declared a seven-day mourning period. Dr. Singh, an esteemed economist, served as India's Prime Minister from 2004 to 2014 and played a crucial role in shaping the country's economic policies. His death has left the nation in grief, and his contributions to India's development will be remembered fondly. The Telangana Assembly will join the rest of the country in paying respects to the late leader during this special session.

#### **KTR Denies Role in Contract Implementation and Fund Transfers Responsibilities Rest with HMDA and Statutory Approvals Refund Application Possible for Unheld Formula E Race**

TPN , Hyderabad: Telangana Minister K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) has filed a reply affidavit in the High Court, asserting that he has no involvement in the implementation of contracts or the payment of funds related to the Formula E race project. In his affidavit, KTR clarified that the procedural responsibilities for contract implementation and fund disbursement do not fall under his purview as a minister. He emphasized that matters related to permissions, fund payments to foreign companies, and associated banking processes are handled by statutory bodies like the Hyderabad Metropolitan De-

velopment Authority (HMDA) and require government approval for amounts exceeding ₹10 crores.

KTR highlighted that HMDA operates under specific statutory rules, and there is no provision that ties him to the transfer of funds or their procedural approvals. He reiterated that he has no role in fund transfers and that all issues related to payments must comply with the law.

Addressing the Formula E race's financial aspects, KTR stated that he took charge as the promoter for the e-car race after these issues



arose. He mentioned that since the 10th season of competitions has not taken place, an application for a refund can be submitted to the Formula E organization.

The affidavit aims to clarify the minister's role amidst legal scrutiny regarding contract payments and procedural lapses associated with the high-profile event.

## **HC Upholds Indiramma Committees for Housing Scheme**

TPN , Hyderabad: The Telangana High Court's division bench has refused to suspend the operations of the Indiramma Committees, which are tasked with selecting beneficiaries for the state's housing scheme designed to assist the homeless poor. The court declined to stay the earlier orders issued by a single judge and directed the state government to file a counter, with the next hearing scheduled for January 24, 2025.The Indiramma housing scheme aims to provide Rs 5 lakh in financial assistance for the construction of 450,000 houses in its initial phase.

This initiative was formalized through a government order dated October 11, which established committees at both village panchayat and municipal ward levels. These committees are chaired by panchayat sarpanches or special officers appointed by the district collector, and include two women from self-help

groups, along with three local representatives from different communities (one each from BC, SC, and ST) in rural areas. In urban areas, ward councillors or corporators serve as chairpersons.

The establishment of these committees was challenged in court by Nithish Kumar and another petitioner from Nizamabad. However, their plea was dismissed by a single judge, who emphasized that the beneficiary selection process would adhere to established eligibility criteria and that the government retains discretionary power in implementing such schemes. The judge further noted that judicial review under Article 226 is limited unless there is a violation of fundamental rights.

This ruling ensures the continued operation of the Indiramma Committees in selecting deserving beneficiaries for the housing scheme.

ically motivated or influenced, stating that the FIR against KTR was filed only after obtaining the necessary approvals from the concerned authorities. The bureau emphasized that business rules were violated when the Municipal Department entered into agreements, and payments to the Formula E Operations (FEO) company were made under KTR's instructions.

The counter also challenged KTR's petition seeking the dismissal of the case, citing it as baseless and an obstruction to the investigation. It noted that Supreme Court orders allow registration of cases without preliminary investigation in instances of serious allegations. The delay in filing the FIR, ACB argued, does not invalidate the seriousness of the charges.

The bureau underscored the need for a thorough investigation, stressing that dismissing the case on irrelevant grounds would set a harmful precedent. It maintained that allegations of misappropriation and misconduct warrant a proper judicial probe.

The High Court is expected to take up the matter soon, as the case continues to stir political and administrative debate in Telangana.

## Bhu Bharati Portal Set to Launch on January 1

Bhu Bharati portal will go live on January 1, marking a significant shift in the state's land records management system. The existing Dharani portal will cease operations on December 31, with all its data being transferred to the National Informatics Center (NIC) for integration into the new platform.

The transition comes amid growing concerns over alleged irregularities in the Dharani portal. Reports of hundreds of acres being removed from restricted lists overnight have caused a stir within the revenue department. Investigations are underway to identify those responsible, focusing on server access logs, IP

Srinivas questioned Kavitha's relevance in fighting for BC issues, stating that the BC community is capable of resolving its own problems through its leadership. He criticized her for not addressing BC issues during her tenure in power, claiming that the leadership of BCs does not need Kavitha's involvement.

Srinivas emphasized that BCs had a significant role in the Telangana state's progress, especially in the 42% reservation for BCs in local bodies. He pointed out that during KCR's tenure, BCs were ignored despite promises for reservations in various sectors, including tribals and minorities. He also criticized the failure of programs meant for BCs, including the BC Corporation, and the denial of loans. Srinivas accused Kavitha of staging a drama to divert attention from other issues, including the liquor case. He called on BCs to avoid participating in any events led by Kavitha, stating that BCs should not be manipulated for political gain by upper-caste interests.

### Harish Rao's Open Letter to CM Revanth **Reddy: Demand for Yam Purchase Centers and Bonus Payment**

TPN, Telangana : Former min- ment for failing to set up purister and BRS leader Harish Rao has addressed an open letter to Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, urging immediate action to support yam farmers in the state. Rao demanded the establishment of yam purchase centers and the payment of a Rs 400 bonus on the support price, as promised by the Congress in its Warangal Rythu Declaration during the elections.

Highlighting the plight of farmers, Rao noted that approximately 2.5 lakh metric tons of yams are expected to be produced across 6 lakh acres in Telangana. He criticized the state governchase centers, leaving farmers dependent on the open market, where they are unable to secure even the minimum support price of Rs 7,550 per quintal. Instead, farmers are reportedly receiving only Rs 6,500 to Rs 6,800 per quintal, resulting in a loss of Rs 800 per quintal.

Harish Rao urged the government to prioritize the establishment of yam purchase centers and ensure farmers receive the promised Rs 400 bonus. He emphasized the need for prompt action to prevent further losses and uphold the commitments made to farmers.

# **Inspection Reveals Critical Issues** at Bollaram Government Hospital



TPN, Telangana : Malkajgiri MP conducted an inspection of Bollaram Government Hospital to review the facilities, patient well-being, and challenges faced by staff and patients. The visit highlighted several issues, including the absence of ultrasound facilities, rabies vaccines, and essential medicines. It was also reported that patients were being charged for X-rays and blood tests, and that doctors were unavailable at night, causing problems during emergencies.

During the visit, the MP met with doctors, staff, and patients in both outpatient and inpatient departments, inquiring about their illnesses and the treatment provided. Bathrooms were also inspected, and recommendations were made to maintain cleanliness.

Speaking to the media, the MP expressed concern over the lack of resources and funds at the hospital, which primarily serves the poorest of the poor. Patients, choosing government hospitals over pri-

vate ones due to affordability, demanded better facilities.

The MP noted that super-specialty hospitals like Gandhi and Osmania are witnessing an increase in patient loads due to reduced facilities, further burdening the healthcare system. The inspection also covered the Cantonment Hospital and Urban Health Center within the Malkajgiri Parliament area, where a service charge of Rs. 50 for doctor consultations was reported.

Efforts will be made to ensure the availability of medicines, equipment, and adequate staff, with a focus on increasing the number of deliveries at the hospital, which currently averages 4-5 per month. As a member of the Cantonment Board, the MP pledged to restore the hospital's former reputation and ensure free healthcare for residents.The program was attended by Hospital Superintendent Dr. Ramakrishna, senior BJP leader V.K. Mahesh, Kompally Councilor Raji Reddy, former Shamirpet MPP Chandrashekhar Yadav, and others.

This hospital, being an integral part of the cantonment area, will receive the necessary attention to improve services and meet public expectations.





## **HYDRA Commissioner Ranganath: Demolitions to Resume Soon**



TPN, Hyderabad: HYDRA Commissioner Ranganath has confirmed that demolitions of illegal constructions on water bodies will resume shortly after the identification of Full Tank Levels (FTL). Despite a temporary pause, the commissioner assured that HYDRA's operations remain robust, with 15 teams actively engaged and plans to expand.

#### Key highlights of Commissioner **Ranganath's statement:**

No Notices for Illegal Constructions: HYDRA does not issue notices for illegal structures on water bodies, as such actions are deemed unlawful.

Operational Coverage: HYDRA's jurisdiction extends up to the Outer Ring Road, focusing on disaster response and asset protection.

Enhanced Public Awareness: Efforts have been made to educate citizens about FTLs and buffer zones, which will soon

## PhD Student Deepti's **Suicide: Police Expedite Investigation**

The police have arrested Deepti's father, Sangeeta Rao,


TPN , Hyderabad: A tragic accident claimed the life of a 33-year-old cyclist in Madhapur on Saturday morning. The victim, identified as Ganesh, was on his way to work around 6:40 AM when he was struck by a speeding car near the Parvat Nagar junction. Due to the impact, Ganesh's head hit the footpath railings, leading to excessive bleeding. He died on the spot.

Ganesh, who worked for a private company, was cycling to work when the fatal incident occurred. The car driver has been taken into police custody, but no formal complaint has yet been filed by the victim's family. The body has been sent for postmortem.

This accident follows another tragic incident just a day earlier at the same spot, where two young individuals were killed in a bike crash with a divider.

# **Two Sentenced to Life Imprisonment for** Murder in LB Nagar

TPN, Hyderabad: On Friday, December 27, the Additional District and Sessions Judge at LB Nagar, Ranga Reddy district, sentenced two men to rigorous life imprisonment for the brutal murder of Sri Ramulu in 2015. The convicted men, Guduru Kumar alias Komaraiah and Kotha Kurva Ramachandraiah alias Ramchendri, were also fined Rs 5,000 each.

The crime occurred on October 23, 2015, when the accused attacked the victim, Sri Ramulu, and stole Rs 11,000 from him. During the attack, one of the victim's testicles was fatally injured. Sri Ramulu was rushed to the government hospital in Chevella, where he succumbed to his injuries while undergoing treatment.

The Chevella police filed the chargesheet on February 16, 2016, and the trial proceeded thereafter. During the trial, the court examined 15 witnesses, and based on the evidence and testimonies, the two accused were found guilty and sentenced to life imprisonment.

# **Hyderabad Police Arrest Three** for Robbery; Weapons Seized

## **Telangana ACB Nabs Two Officials for Bribery**



TPN, Hyderabad: Telangana's Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) apprehended two government officials in separate incidents for demanding bribes to perform official duties.

In the first case, a deputy tehsildar of Shankarapatnam Mandal in Siddipet district was caught red-handed accepting a bribe of ₹6,000. The bribe was sought from a complainant to forward a file for the Nala conversion of agricultural land measuring 2.25 guntas to the tahsildar. ACB officials recovered the bribe amount from the deputy tehsildar, with a chemical test confirming traces of the bribe money on his right hand. The accused was later produced before the Special Judge for SPE & ACB cases in Karimnagar. In another case earlier in the day, ACB officials arrested Merugu Rathnam, a deputy surveyor from Dammannapet Mandal in Bhadradri Kothagudem district. He was caught demanding and accepting ₹50,000 from a complainant for conducting a land survey and preparing an official report for a property owned by the complainant's sister. The ACB urged citizens to report any incidents of bribery by calling their hotline at \*1064\*. These arrests underline the agency's commitment to eliminating corruption and ensuring accountability among government officials.

## Annual Crime Report 2024: **Sharp Rise in Cheating** Cases in Khammam

TPN , Khammam: The annual crime report for 2024 revealed a significant increase in cheating cases and economic offences under the Khammam Police Commissionerate limits. The overall crime rate rose by 16%, with property-related crimes increasing by 50.2% and economic offences by 63%. Cheating cases witnessed a staggering rise of 112.3%, with 397 cases reported in 2024 compared to 187 in 2023. Additionally, cybercrimes surged, with 276 cases registered this year against 219 last year. Releasing the report, Commissioner of Police Sunil Dutt highlighted the improved detection of property offences, which rose by 22.4% due to the efforts of the clues team and extensive use of CCTV cameras. A total of 8,873 FIRs were filed in 2024, compared to 7,667 in 2023.

#### Other notable statistics include:

Economic Offences : Increased from 446 in 2023 to 727 in 2024. Crime Against Women : Rose by 10%. Atrocities Against SC/STs : Jumped by 14.63%. Murders: Declined slightly, with 26 reported in 2024 compared to 28 in 2023.

While certain crimes such as robberies, house break-ins, and sexual jealousy cases decreased due to intensified patrolling and use of fingerprint devices, road accidents, missing persons, and kidnapping cases saw an uptick. Road accidents rose from 701 in 2023 to 785 in 2024, and missing cases increased from 438 to 558. The Commissioner emphasized the ongoing efforts to strengthen law enforcement and community safety measures.

# **Choice Of Manmohan Singh Funeral Site An "Insult", Says Rahul Gandhi; BJP Hits Back**



The controversy surrounding the site chosen for Dr. Manmohan Singh's last rites took a political turn today after Congress leader Rahul Gandhi accused the government of showing disrespect to the former prime minister. Dr. Singh, who passed away on December 26 at the age of 92, was cremated at Nigambodh Ghat in Delhi with full state honours. However, the location sparked a row, with Gandhi suggesting it was an "insult" to Singh's legacy.

Rahul Gandhi, the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, took to social media to express his displeasure, questioning the decision to conduct Dr. Singh's funeral at Nigambodh Ghat. He claimed the site was not in keeping with the tradition of giving former prime ministers a dignified memorial. "The great son of Mother India and the first Prime Minister from the Sikh community, Dr. Manmohan Singh ji, has been insulted by this government. His last rites were performed at Nigambodh Ghat today, which is a disrespectful departure from past practices," Gandhi wrote on X.

Gandhi emphasized that previous prime ministers had been given dignified memorials where people could pay homage with ease. "Dr. Singh, who served as prime minister for a decade and helped elevate India's economic standing, deserves far more. His policies continue to benefit the poor and marginalized sections of our society, and yet he was not afforded the respect he was due," he added, calling for a memorial to honor Singh's contributions to the nation.

Sambit Patra dismissed Gandhi's criticism, labeling it a new low in Indian politics. "Rahul Gandhi's remarks are shameful, especially considering that the cabinet, following Dr. Singh's death, decided to honor him with a memorial. A letter was sent to Congress and Dr. Singh's family proposing the creation of this memorial," Patra said during a press conference.

The BJP further accused the Congress party of hypocrisy, pointing to instances in the past where Congress had allegedly shown disrespect toward its own leaders, such as former Prime Minister PV Narasimha Rao and former President Pranab Mukherjee.

Dr. Singh's body was taken to Nigambodh Ghat in a flower-decked vehicle, accompanied by tight security and a large crowd of supporters. Rahul Gandhi walked beside the procession and later participated in carrying the casket to the pyre. The funeral ceremony was attended by several dignitaries, including President Droupadi Murmu, Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar, and Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Congress leaders Sonia Gandhi, Mallikarjun Kharge, and Jairam Ramesh were present, alongside senior BJP leaders Amit Shah and Rajnath Singh.

Foreign dignitaries also attended the ceremony to pay their respects, including Bhutanese King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck and Mauritius Foreign Minister Dhananjay Ramful.

The final rites saw Dr. Singh's eldest daughter, Upinder Singh, light the funeral pyre, as Sikh priests recited Gurbani hymns. The ceremony armed forces, honoring Dr. Singh's legacy and contributions to India.



# **Homelessness in the U.S. Hits Alarming Record**

The homelessness crisis in the United States has reached an unprecedented scale, resembling a storm growing silently over the ocean before crashing onto shore with devastating force. According to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) latest report, a staggering 771,480 people were homeless on a single night in January 2024. This marks the highest figure ever recorded and reflects an 18.1% surge compared to the previous year.

This sharp increase sheds light on longstanding systemic issues, including stagnant wages, skyrocketing housing costs, and the lingering impacts of natural disasters. HUD's findings underscore the intersection of economic instability, housing shortages, and climate crises, which together create a perfect storm for those already teetering on the edge of financial security.

The crisis has been especially acute in states like Illinois and Hawaii. Illinois reported a jaw-dropping 116.2% rise in homelessness, primarily driven by an influx of migrants seeking shelter in cities like Chicago. Meanwhile, Hawaii faced an 87% increase in its homeless population due to devastating wildfires that displaced hundreds last year. These statistics highlight the interconnected nature of homelessness, where factors such as economic uncertainty, environmental disasters, and insufficient affordable housing exacerbate an already dire situation.

Adrianne Todman, HUD's Deputy Secretary, has emphasized that "no American should endure homelessness," yet the statistics paint millions vulnerable to the harsh realities of a grim picture. Children and families are life without stable shelter? The stakes have bearing the brunt of this crisis, with nearly never been higher, and the nation's response 150,000 children reported homeless—a 33% will define its commitment to addressing one increase from 2023. Family homelessness also of the most pressing humanitarian issues of surged by 40%, driven by mounting financial

pressures and unaffordable rent hikes. The data also reveal stark racial disparities. Black Americans, who make up just 12% of the U.S. population, account for 32% of the homeless population. This alarming disparity underscores the persistent impact of structural racism on housing insecurity, highlighting the urgent need for targeted policies to address racial inequities and promote housing stability.

The homelessness crisis extends beyond mere numbers; it is a humanitarian catastrophe that threatens to reshape the social fabric of the nation. Without significant policy interventions and increased investments in affordable housing, homelessness risks becoming a permanent feature of American life. Measures such as rent control, increased wages, and robust social safety nets could play a pivotal role in reversing the current trajectory.

The situation calls for immediate action to prevent further escalation. Policymakers must prioritize funding for affordable housing projects, expand emergency shelters, and implement programs that address the root causes of homelessness, such as income inequality and inadequate access to mental health services.

As the crisis deepens, its ripple effects could lead to greater social instability and economic strain across communities. The time to act is now. The question remains: will the U.S. rise to meet this challenge, or will homelessness continue to grow unchecked, leaving our time.

## "Fewer Re-Runs Of Friends, More Books": Vivek Ramaswamy On H1B Row

Vivek Ramaswamy, the entrepreneur and former Republican presidential candidate, has weighed in on the ongoing debate over immigration and hiring trends in the U.S. tech sector. His comments, posted on X (formerly Twitter), came amid growing discussions about Indian immigrants' success in the United States and the cultural implications of the H1B visa program. Ramaswamy, who is set to lead the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE) alongside Elon Musk in the upcoming Donald Trump administration, called for a cultural shift in the U.S. to prioritize excellence, achievement, and hard work over mediocrity.

Ramaswamy, a first-generation U.S. citizen whose parents immigrated from India, argued that the reason many top tech companies hire foreign-born and first-generation engineers is not due to an innate IQ advantage, but a cultural difference. He rejected the idea that these workers are chosen because they are inherently smarter than native-born Americans. Instead, Ramaswamy suggested that it is American culture that needs to change to ensure global competitiveness.

He highlighted a shift in American culture that began in the 1990s, which, according to him, has been more focused on social conformity and popularity than on academic and intellectual excellence. Ramaswamy claimed that American society began to value normalcy and mediocrity over achievement, a trend that is reflected in popular media and school systems. He criticized shows like Boy Meets World, Saved by the Bell, and Family Matters for portraying characters who prioritized social status over intellectual pursuits.

In contrast, Ramaswamy pointed out that immigrant parents, particularly those from India, often place greater emphasis on academic success, particularly in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields.



He described how many immigrant parents actively discouraged their children from watching television shows that promoted what he termed "mediocrity," encouraging them instead to focus on their studies and participate in extracurricular academic activities.

To support his argument, Ramaswamy proposed a cultural shift in the U.S. that would prioritize "achievement over normalcy, excellence over mediocrity, nerdiness over conformity, and hard work over laziness." He suggested that American youth should focus more on activities like math tutoring, weekend science competitions, and reading books, and less on social activities like sleepovers, Saturday morning cartoons, and hanging out at the mall. He emphasized that

this cultural shift is necessary if the U.S. wants to remain competitive in a hyper-competitive global market for technical talent.

Ramaswamy acknowledged that such an approach is often met with skepticism in American society. Many American parents view the intense focus on academics as extreme, and children who excel in STEM fields are often seen as "nerds" or outliers. However, Ramaswamy argued that this mindset is counterproductive in the global competition for top talent. He warned that if the U.S. continues to venerate mediocrity over excellence, it risks falling behind countries like China in the race for technological advancement.

He referred to the current moment as America's

"Sputnik moment," drawing a parallel to the Cold War-era launch of the Soviet Union's first satellite, which spurred the U.S. to accelerate its space program. Ramaswamy expressed hope that the election of Donald Trump could mark the beginning of a new era in America, but only if the country undergoes a cultural awakening to prioritize achievement and excellence. Ramaswamy's call for cultural change comes amid broader discussions about the H1B visa

program, which allows U.S. companies to hire foreign workers, particularly in the tech industry. Critics argue that the program displaces American workers, while supporters, including Ramaswamy, suggest that it helps bring in top talent from around the world, which is essential for maintaining U.S. global leadership in innovation.

Ramaswamy concluded by urging Americans to stop focusing on victimhood or legislating alternative hiring practices, and instead to address the cultural issues that are hindering the country's ability to compete on a global stage. He expressed confidence that the U.S. can make this cultural shift and become a global leader in innovation once again.

In a related note, Canadian musician Grimes, Elon Musk's former partner, also addressed the rising anti-India sentiment on social media. She defended Indian culture, recalling her own experiences growing up in a half-Indian household, and emphasized that Indian culture blends well with Western values.

Ramaswamy's comments have sparked a significant conversation about how U.S. culture can evolve to foster a competitive, achievement-driven society in the face of global challenges. Whether this shift will take place remains to be seen, but it underscores the ongoing debate over immigration, hiring practices, and the future of America's global standing in the tech industry.





# Farewell to Manmohan Singh

## Last Rites Held With State Honours, Nation Pays Tribute

**TPN Correspondent** New Delhi, Dec 29

Former Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh, regarded as the "architect of India's economic reforms," was laid to rest with full state honours on Saturday at Nigambodh Ghat in Delhi. Dr. Singh, who served two terms as Prime Minister from 2004 to 2014 in the Congress-led UPA government, passed away at the age of 92 due to age-related complications.

The funeral was attended by a host of political dignitaries, including President Droupadi Murmu, Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar, Prime Achievements Minister Narendra Modi, Bhutan's Prime Minister Tshering Tobgay, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge, and members of the Gandhi family, including Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi.

The Centre declared a seven-day state mourning in honour of Dr. Singh, during which the national flag will fly at half-mast across the country. The Congress party also announced the cancellation of its official programs, including its Foundation Day celebration, for the next seven days. These activities will resume on January 3.

### **Political Dispute Over Memorial Site**

A political dispute erupted between the Centre and the Congress over the location for Dr. Singh's memorial. The Congress party expressed disappointment with the selection of Nigambodh Ghat for the last rites, arguing that it was not suitable for a memorial. Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge wrote to Prime Minister Modi, requesting that the location of the final rites be preserved for a memorial, as is customary for former leaders and Prime Ministers.

In response, BJP spokesperson CR Kesavan criticized the Congress for its stance, calling it "ironic" given that the Congress-led UPA government had not built a memorial for former Prime Minister Narasimha Rao, who passed away in 2004.

The Centre, however, clarified that it would allocate a suitable space for Dr. Singh's memorial and had already communicated this to Kharge and Dr. Singh's family.

Sharmistha Mukherjee, daughter of the late former President Pranab Mukherjee, also criticized Kharge's request. In a statement on X, she pointed out that when her father passed away in 2020, the Congress leadership did not even convene a condolence meeting, let alone discuss a memorial for him.

## **All-Woman Team To Investigate Anna University Rape** Survivor To Receive Rs 25 Lakh Compensation

The Madras High Court has directed the formation of a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to probe the recent alleged sexual assault of a woman student at Anna University in Chennai. The SIT will consist of three women IPS officers, ensuring a sensitive and thorough investigation.

The court also ordered the state government to provide the victim with a compensation of Rs 25 lakh. This ruling came during the hearing of a plea seeking to transfer the investigation to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

In addition, the bench, comprising Justice S. M. Subramaniam and Justice V. Lakshminarayan, emphasized that the survivor's education should not be disrupted by the traumatic event. The court instructed Anna University not to charge any fees from her during this period.

The incident, which has sparked widespread outrage from opposition parties and civil society, led to one arrest so far. The court's intervention aims to ensure justice for the victim and uphold her rights throughout the investigation.

### Manipur CM Condemns Indiscriminate Firing by Kuki Militants; Two Injured

Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh strongly condemned the "indiscriminate firing" by Kuki militants on two villages in Imphal East district on Friday, which resulted in the injury of a policeman and a civilian. The attack, which originated from the hills, targeted the villages of Sanasabi and Thamnapokpi, causing widespread panic in the area. In a post on X (formerly Twitter), the

Chief Minister expressed his outrage, calling the attack a "cowardly and unprovoked assault on innocent lives." He emphasized that the attack undermined peace and harmony, and called on both central forces and state police to coordinate effectively in such situations.

"Strongly condemn the indiscriminate firing by Kuki militants at Sanasabi and Thamnapokpi in Imphal East, which injured civilians and security personnel. This cowardly and unprovoked attack on innocent lives is an assault on peace and harmony," the Chief Minister said. He further assured that adequate security personnel had been dispatched to the affected areas and that the injured were receiving medical assistance. Singh appealed for calm and unity in the face of such challenges. The two targeted villages are located at the foothills of the region. Disturbing visuals from the area showed people from the Meitei community, including elderly women and children, fleeing the violence as automatic gunfire echoed in the background.

# 5,000 Tourists Rescued in Himachal's Kullu Amid Heavy Snowfall

Around 5,000 tourists stranded in Solang Nala, a popular ski resort in Himachal Pradesh's Kullu, were rescued on Friday following heavy snowfall in the region. The Kullu police launched a rescue operation on December 27 after approximately 1,000 vehicles, carrying tourists and other travelers, became stuck due to the snow. "Due to fresh snowfall on December 27, about

1,000 vehicles, including those carrying around 5,000 tourists, were stranded in Solang Nala. Kullu Police successfully rescued the tourists and transported them to safe locations. The rescue operation is ongoing," the Kullu police stated in a post on X.

The ongoing snowfall has caused widespread disruptions across the state, with the India Meteorological Department (IMD) issuing an orange alert for heavy snowfall and cold waves on December 27 and 28. Himachal Pradesh has

been experiencing intense weather conditions, particularly in the districts of Lahaul-Spiti, Chamba, Kangra, Kullu, Shimla, and Kinnaur. The IMD forecasted that from December 29 onwards, a renewed cold wave will affect the plains, including Bilaspur, Hamirpur, and Una districts. Mandi, Kullu, and Chamba are also expected to face severe cold conditions until January 1. Dense fog is predicted for isolated areas on January 1, further complicating travel with reduced visibility.








# **Bhutan Holds Special Prayers for Manmohan** Singh, King Attends Funeral in Delhi

Bhutan paid tribute to former Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh with special prayers and ceremonies on Saturday, following his passing. King Jigme Khesar Namgyel Wangchuck led the nation in honoring Dr. Singh, attending his funeral in Delhi, a day after offering prayers at a Buddhist monastery in Thimphu.

Separate prayer ceremonies were held across all 20 Dzongkhags (districts) of Bhutan in his memory, the Bhutan government confirmed. The royal family, along with senior government officials, participated in the ceremonies, which included lighting a thousand butter lamps at Thimphu's Kuenrey of Tashichhodzong, led by the King. Prime Minister Tshering Tobgay, Indian Ambassador Sudhakar Dalela, and members of the Bhutanese royal family were also present.

As a mark of respect, Bhutan's national flag was flown at half-mast throughout the country and at its embassies and consulates worldwide. "As a mark of respect to the late former prime minister and in solidarity with the government and people of India, all national flags across the country and at Bhutan's embassies, missions, and consulates abroad are being flown at half-mast," the Bhutanese government stated.

On Saturday, King Wangchuck attended



Dr. Singh's funeral at Nigambodh Ghat in Delhi, paying his respects in person. Dr. Singh, who served as India's prime minister from 2004 to 2014, was widely regarded as the architect of India's economic reforms. He passed away on Thursday at the age of 92 at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS).

Under Dr. Singh's leadership, India-Bhutan relations flourished, particularly in the areas of trade and hydro-power cooperation. Suchir Balaji, a former researcher at OpenAI, was found dead in his San Francisco apartment last month. Known for his criticism of the company. Balaii had accused OpenAI of violating copyright laws, particularly in its use of internet-sourced data to train its AI models. His tragic death came just a month after he publicly shared his concerns. In an interview with Business Insider, Balaji's mother, Poornima Ramarao, spoke about her son's growing disillusionment with OpenAI and the factors that led to his decision to leave the company. She revealed that Balaji believed OpenAI had deviated from its original mission, moving away from being a nonprofit, open-source initiative to a more commercially-driven organization. His concerns deepened as OpenAI launched ChatGPT, a product built with the data he had contributed to for GPT-4. Ramarao said her son felt that artificial intelligence posed a danger to humanity. The ideological clash between his values and OpenAI's corporate direction ultimately led him to resign in August.

Indian-American community leaders have strongly condemned the racist attacks on Sriram Krishnan, who was recently appointed by President-elect Donald Trump as Senior AI Advisor. The attacks, which targeted Krishnan's Indian origin, have been denounced by groups including Indiaspora, emphasizing that there is no place for racial discrimination in public discourse.

In a media advisory issued on Saturday, the Indian-American diaspora expressed its support for Krishnan, condemning the "reprehensible racist attacks" directed at him. Krishnan previously served as a General Partner at Andreessen Horowitz and invested in prominent firms like SpaceX and Figma. Krishnan holds a Bachelor of Technology in Information Technology from SRM Engineering College, Anna University.

## **Nonimmigrant Visas To Indians** For 2nd Year: US Embassy

The US mission in India announced on Friday that it issued over one million nonimmigrant visas in 2024, marking the second consecutive year of surpassing this milestone. This includes a record number of visitor visas, reflecting the growing demand among Indians for travel to the US for tourism, business, and education.

In the past four years, the number of Indian visitors to the US has increased fivefold, with over two million Indians traveling to the US in the first 11 months of 2024, a 26% rise from the previous year. The embassy also highlighted the success of a pilot program allowing Indian H-1B visa holders to renew their visas without leaving the US, with plans to formalize this process in 2025. Additionally, the mission issued tens of thousands of immigrant visas, contributing to family reunification and the migration of skilled professionals. India continues to be the top sender of international students to the US, with over 331,000 students studying there in 2024, marking the highest number since the 2008/2009 academic year.

# **Putin Apologizes to Azerbaijan Over Plane Crash in Russian Airspace**



an apology to Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev following the tragic crash of an Azerbaijan Airlines passenger plane in Russian airspace on Wednesday. The plane, Flight J2-8243, crashed in a fiery explosion near Aktau in Kazakhstan after diverting from southern Russia, where Ukrainian drone attacks were reported in several cities.

The incident, which resulted in the deaths of at least 38 people, occurred after the plane attempted to land at Grozny Airport in Chechnya. As the aircraft was attempting to land, Ukrainian drones were reportedly attacking cities including Grozny, Mozdok, and Vladikavkaz. Russian air defense systems successfully repelled these attacks, but the plane was forced to divert from its intended route.

Russian President Vladimir Putin has issued In a statement released by the Kremlin on Saturday, President Putin extended his "deep and sincere condolences" to the families of the victims and wished a speedy recovery to the injured passengers. "President Vladimir Putin apologised for the tragic incident that occurred in Russian airspace," the statement read. The plane was originally traveling on its scheduled route when it encountered difficulties, prompting multiple attempts to land at Grozny airport. Despite the efforts, the aircraft tragically crashed, sparking a ball of fire upon impact near the city of Aktau in Kazakhstan. The Azerbaijani authorities are investigating the

incident, while Putin's apology marks a significant diplomatic gesture following the tragedy. The crash has raised concerns over the safety of air travel in the region amid ongoing conflicts.

# **India's Forex Reserves Decline by** \$8.4 Billion to \$644.3 Billion: RBI

Tndia's foreign exchange re **L**serves have experienced a significant decline, falling by \$8.478 billion to \$644.391 billion for the week ending December 20, 2024, according to data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Friday. This follows a decrease of \$1.988 billion in the previous week, marking a continued downtrend in the country's forex reserves.

The decline has been attributed to a combination of factors, including the revaluation of reserves and interventions in the foreign exchange market by the RBI to stabilize the rupee amidst market fluctuations. At their peak, India's forex reserves had reached a record high of \$704.885 billion at the end of September 2024. For the week ending December 20, foreign currency assets, which form a major component of the reserves, fell by \$6.014 billion, bringing the total to \$556.562 billion. These assets reflect the effect of changes in the value of non-US currencies such as the euro, pound, and yen, which are part of India's forex holdings.



# **RBI's New UPI Rule Set to Transform Digital Payments in India**

Tn a significant move to enhance the digital payment ecosystem in India, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) recently announced that users of prepaid payment instruments (PPIs) will now be able to use third-party applications for UPI transactions. This shift is expected to greatly improve the flexibility and convenience of digital payments across the country.

To understand the implications of this decision, it's important to first differentiate between two key digital payment systems: Unified Payments Interface (UPI) and Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs).

UPI vs PPIs: What's the Difference?

UPI, which stands for Unified Payments Interface, is a real-time payment system that allows users to send money directly between bank accounts. UPI apps, such as Google Pay, BHIM, and PhonePe, enable seamless bank-to-bank transfers via mobile numbers and QR codes. UPI transactions are instant and linked directly to a user's bank account.

In contrast, Prepaid Payment Instruments (PPIs) are essentially mobile wallets, like MobiKwik or Paytm, that store prepaid balances which can be used for transactions within the same app or ecosystem. PPIs are not directly linked to bank accounts, meaning users can only transfer funds within the same platform or wallet, restricting interoperability.

This is where the RBI's new rule comes into play. Until now, users of PPIs could only make UPI transactions using the UPI functionality offered by the PPI provider itself. For example, MobiKwik users could only use its own "Pocket UPI" to make transfers, while PhonePe users were restricted to using BHIM for UPI payments. The new rule, however, breaks down this limitation and allows users to link their PPI accounts with third-party UPI apps.



### The Impact of the New Rule

Under the new guidelines, which were officially rolled out on December 27, 2024, users of PPIs like MobiKwik and PhonePe will be able to make UPI payments through any third-party UPI application. This means that a MobiKwik user can now make UPI payments using Google Pay or PhonePe, and vice versa. This will enhance the interoperability between various payment systems, offering users greater flexibility in making digital payments. The change follows a statement made by the RBI in April 2024, which outlined plans to enable interoperability for PPIs through third-party UPI apps. Prior to this, PPIs were limited to using only

the UPI functionality provided by the respective PPI issuers. The RBI's latest move is seen as a step toward creating a more inclusive and accessible digital payment system.

This development is expected to significantly streamline the digital payment process for users who rely on mobile wallets. # **Delhi Records Highest Single-Day December Rainfall in 101 Years**

This marks the highest December rainfall in 101 years, according to the India Meteorological Department (IMD). The previous record for the highest single-day





This downpour also placed December 2024 among the top five wettest months of December in Delhi's history, making it the fifth-highest since records began in 1901. The IMD noted that the 24-hour rainfall total at Safdarjung station was the second-highest on record.

On Saturday, Delhi woke up to an overcast sky, with the IMD forecasting more light to moderate rain throughout the day and issuing a yellow alert. The rainfall is being driven by an active western disturbance interacting with easterly winds, affecting Northwest and Central India, including Delhi-NCR. The minimum temperature on Saturday was recorded at 12.7°C, six degrees above the season's average, providing some relief from the usual winter chill.

In terms of air quality, Delhi saw an improvement, with the

Air Quality Index (AQI) moving into the 'moderate' category. At 9 am on Saturday, the AQI stood at 152, according to data from the Central Pollution Control Board. AQI values between 101 and 200 are classified as 'moderate,' indicating a slight health concern for sensitive individuals.

The unusual weather patterns this December highlight the ongoing shifts in climate, with the IMD continuing to monitor conditions closely.

# Gus Atkinson, Saim Ayub, Shamar **Joseph, Kamindu Mendis Up for ICC Men's Emerging Cricketer of the Year**

The nominees for the prestigious  $T_{\rm ICC}$  Men's Emerging Cricketer of the Year Award 2024 have been announced, with exciting young talents from around the globe in the running. Gus Atkinson (England), Kamindu Mendis (Sri Lanka), Saim Ayub (Pakistan), and Shamar Joseph (West Indies) have all earned nominations for their exceptional performances over the past year.

Gus Atkinson, the English pacer, has made an impressive mark since his debut in July, during James Anderson's final Test. The 26-year-old's stunning performance at Lord's against the West Indies, where he took a career-best 7/45 followed by a five-wicket haul in the second innings, helped him record the fourth-best debut figures in men's Test cricket history. Atkinson has since become a key figure in England's pace attack, claiming 34 wickets in home Tests and contributing to the team's historic series win in New Zealand. He also showcased his batting prowess with a brilliant 101ball century against Sri Lanka.

Kamindu Mendis has been a revelation in Sri Lanka's batting lineup, notching up 1,049 runs in nine Tests this year, including five centuries. His

remarkable consistency saw him equal Sir Don Bradman's record of reaching 1,000 Test runs in just 13 innings. Mendis's career-best knock of 182 against New Zealand played a vital role in Sri Lanka's 2-0 series win and bolstered their World Test Championship campaign. He also impressed with 267 runs in England, contributing to Sri Lanka's first Test victory in England in a decade.

Saim Ayub of Pakistan, aged just 22, has captivated the cricket world with his fearless batting at the top of the order. Ayub's contributions were pivotal in Pakistan's successful series wins against Australia, Zimbabwe, and South Africa. He scored two centuries in South Africa, earning the Player of the Series award in the process. Ayub also impressed with the ball, taking five wickets in ODIs at an economy rate of 4.63. His match-winning knock of 109 against South Africa in a tense chase exemplified his





all-round abilities.

Shamar Joseph, the 22-year-old West Indies pacer, has emerged as one of the most promising talents in world cricket. Joseph's debut in Australia saw him play a crucial role in the West Indies' first Test win in Australia since 1997. He took 13 wickets in just two Tests, including two five-wicket hauls. His brilliant 7/68 at the Gabba, delivered through pain, was key to securing a historic eight-run win for the West Indies. Joseph continued his strong form with 12 wickets in home series against Bangladesh and South Africa.

These four emerging stars have taken the cricketing world by storm, and their exceptional performances in 2024 have earned them nominations for one of the most coveted individual awards in the sport. The winner will be announced as part of the ICC Men's Awards later this year.

## **Gutsy Nitish Reddy's Maiden Ton Keeps India** Afloat vs Australia

Nitish Reddy, a relatively unknown entity in Test cricket before the Border-Gavaskar series, emerged as India's savior on Day 3 of the Boxing Day Test in Melbourne, playing a gutsy knock that took India to 358/9. His unbeaten 105 not only gave India a fighting chance but also severely dented Australia's hopes of securing an early win. Despite being 116 runs behind Australia's first-innings total of 474, Reddy's dogged century ensured that India remained in the contest, with rain bringing an early end to play.

Reddy's stellar performance was pivotal in India's recovery, especially after the dismissal of Rishabh Pant, whose rash shot left India struggling

at 191/6. The 21-year-old Andhra Pradesh cricketer's innings was a masterclass in resilience. His 127run partnership with Washington Sundar (50 off 162 balls) helped India claw back into the game, shifting the momentum in their favor. The young batter's composure under pressure drew praise from cricket legend Sunil Gavaskar, who hailed it as one of the greatest knocks in Test history, given the circumstances. As Reddy neared his maiden Test century, the tension rose. He could have been stranded on 99 when Jasprit Bumrah was dismissed, leaving Reddy to face the Australian bowlers with last-man Mohammed Siraj at the crease. Despite the pressure, Siraj survived three deliveries, allowing Reddy to bring up his hundred in style.

A picture-perfect straight drive off Scott Boland marked the moment of triumph, and Reddy took a knee, helmet in hand, acknowledging



the Indian dug-out, which rose in appreciation. The celebration was pure drama—Reddy struck a 'Pushpa' pose after reaching fifty and later mimicked the 'Bahubali' stance to celebrate his century. Reddy's father, Muthyala, watching from the stands, was overcome with emotion as his son reached the milestone, reflecting on the family's sacrifices. A decade ago, when Reddy's father took a financial risk to support his son's cricketing dreams, many advised against it, but today, Reddy's performances are proving them right.

With 10 boundaries and a six, Reddy's attacking game was evident. His stable defense and calculated aggression underlined his maturity, making him India's most consistent batter of the series. His performance has not only kept India in the game but also provided hope that they can turn the match around at the MCG.

The pivotal moment in the match came in the 14th over when New Zealand's Jacob

Duffy delivered a game-changing spell, taking three wickets in a single over. Duffy first had Kusal Mendis (46) caught behind, before dismissing Kusal Perera and Kamindu Mendis for ducks on consecutive deliveries, reducing Sri Lanka to 121 for 3.

Duffy's figures of 4-0-21-3 helped break the chase wide open, and although Sri Lanka still had seven wickets in hand with 29 runs required from the last three overs, they couldn't recover. Young pacer Zakary Foulkes struck another blow when Charith Asalanka pulled a short delivery straight into the hands of deep square leg.

Despite Bhanuka Rajapaksa surviving a DRS review for an LBW decision, he hit back-to-back boundaries in the 18th over, keeping Sri Lanka's hopes alive. However, Tim Robinson's stunning catch dismissed Nissanka (90), and Matt Henry

sent Rajapaksa packing in the penultimate over. Foulkes sealed the win by taking the final two wickets, including a run-out to dismiss Wanindu Hasaranga, as New Zealand triumphed. Earlier, New Zealand's batting was under pressure after losing early wickets, but Daryl Mitchell (62) and Michael Bracewell (59) rescued the team with a 110-run partnership.
