TDP, BJP Likely to Share AP's RS Seats; Janasena to Skip?

TPN, Avinash: Andhra Pradesh is gearing up for its upcoming Rajya Sabha elections, and backroom political maneuvering is in full swing. According to sources, the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) and Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) are set to secure two of the three vacant Rajya Sabha seats. Interestingly, the third seat is also speculated to go to TDP, making it a clean sweep for the NDA alliance in the state. As per sources, TDP has nominated Beeda Mastan Rao for one of the Rajya Sabha seats, while BJP has selected R Krishnaiah. Notably, both these leaders

previously served as Rajya Sabha MPs representing YSRCP, before parting ways with the party following its defeat in the 2024 general elections. The decision to nominate them under the NDA banner reflects the ongoing political shifts in Andhra Pradesh. The third seat, as hinted, may also be allocated to TDP. However, there is no confirmation on this as yet. Meanwhile, Janasena, a key ally of the NDA in Andhra Pradesh, appears to have opted out of the race.





TPN, Vizag: Visakhapatnam is set to welcome another prestigious IT company to its shores. All necessary permissions have been secured for the establishment of a major IT company in the city. The Andhra Pradesh government has given the green light for TCS to set up operations in Visakhapatnam by approving the lease agreement for the Dallas Technologies building. Officials estimate that the company will provide employment to 2,000 people in its first phase. Strategically, TCS has chosen this location next to Infosys.

APIIC had allotted 7,774.90 square meters of land on Hill-2 in 2016 to Dallas Technologies Company for its headquarters in Visakhapatnam. Construction of the ground-plus-three-storey building began two years ago, and the company is now ready to begin operations. The facility has the capacity to employ up to 1,400 people. Earlier this

month, a TCS team visited Visakhapatnam to finalize arrangements for starting their operations and was impressed by the Dallas building. They engaged in discussions and secured an agreement to lease the premises. The Andhra Pradesh government has officially issued orders permitting TCS to lease the building. The government has stipulated that jobs must be created as per the rules. A directive has been issued to grant the requested space for setback benefits and collect Rs. 10,000 per square meter. The Municipal Administration and Urban Development Department has been instructed to promptly inspect the building and issue an occupancy certificate in compliance with regulations. Furthermore, the government has instructed all relevant departments to expedite the necessary processes to ensure that the company can commence operations without delay.





Cabinet Meeting Advanced to 3rd

Key Decisions on Welfare and Kakinada Port Issue

TPN, Amaravati: The Andhra Pradesh government is moving forward with significant policy decisions. The coalition government has completed six months in power, and administrative measures are now being aligned with political priorities. The cabinet meeting, originally scheduled for the 4th of this month, has been advanced to the 3rd. Key issues such as final guidelines for new ration cards, pension applications, and measures to address the rice mafia allegations raised by Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan will be discussed in this meet-

The rescheduling of the cabinet meeting highlights its urgency. Discussions will cover administrative and political matters, including the cancellation of existing ration cards and the issuance of new ones. Applications for these cards will commence tomorrow. Since welfare schemes rely on ration cards, the cabinet is expected to finalize the guidelines for their issuance. Similarly, decisions on sanctioning new pensions are anticipated. The government plans to launch Janmabhoomi-2 on January 2, with new ration cards and pensions being



distributed during the program. The meeting will finalize the action plan for Janmabhoomi-2 and address issues related to the cancellation of ration cards and pensions for ineligible beneficiaries. The government has decided to redesign the ration cards entirely. Another important agenda item is the proposed free bus scheme for women, expected to be implemented during Sankranti. Additionally, discussions will be held on de-

positing Rs 20,000 into farmers' accounts as part of the welfare initiatives.

Politically, the meeting is crucial. Allegations of increasing political interference in sand and liquor policies have been raised, and these issues are likely to be addressed. Pawan Kalyan's recent comments regarding the smuggling of rice from Kakinada have sparked widespread debate. The cabinet is expected to discuss and for-

mulate measures to curb illegal rice smuggling and ensure that public distribution rice reaches its intended beneficiaries.

Other critical issues, such as the Adani power procurement bribery allegations and the purported role of former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy in the case, will also be on the agenda. This meeting is poised to set the tone for the government's upcoming administrative and political strategies.

10 Killed in Three Separate Road Accidents in AP

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: Andhra Pradesh witnessed a series of tragic road accidents over the weekend, claiming 10 lives, including two doctors from Karnataka. The accidents, reported in three districts, highlight the perils of road travel in adverse conditions.

In Anantapur district, a car carrying four people veered off course and crashed into a roadside tree near Vidapanakal village early Sunday morning. Three individuals, including two doctors from Karnataka, lost their lives in the accident.

Police revealed that dense fog likely impaired visibility, causing the driver to lose control. The deceased were identified as Yogesh (52) and Govindaraju (54), both doctors at a government hospital in Bellary, Karnataka, along with the car's driver, Venkata Naidu (53). A fourth passenger, Dr. Amar Goud (55), was critically injured and is undergoing treatment in Bellary. The group was returning from a vacation in Hong Kong, having landed at Bengaluru airport earlier that night.

In Vizianagaram district, four people were killed late Saturday night when their car suffered a tyre burst, hit a divider, and collided with an oncoming truck near Polipally in Bhogapauram Mandal. The victims included G. Kaushik (27), a

The victims included G. Kaushik (27), a jeweler traveling to Visakhapatnam Airport to receive his uncle arriving from the United States; V. Abhinav (27), his wife Manimala (24), and the driver, M. Jayesh (20). Police suspect the burst tyre caused the driver to lose control, leading to the fatal crash.

In Krishna district, a car collided with a minivan after a tyre burst on the Kankipadu flyover, claiming three lives.

The car's occupants, Yesu Prabhu (29), Chinta Ravi (38), and Chili Bhanu (27), all residents of Machilipatnam, were returning from Vijayawada after attending personal errands.

Andhra Pradesh Increases Retirement Age for Judicial Officers



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The retirement age for judicial officers in Andhra Pradesh has

officially been raised from 60 to 61 years following approval from Governor Justice Abdul Nazeer. The amended law has been published in the state gazette under the guidance of the law department, marking its formal implementation.

The decision to extend the retirement age was part of the "AP Government Employees' Retirement Age Rationalization Amendment Bill," introduced during a recent legislative session. Law Minister Payyavula Keshav presented the bill, which garnered unanimous support in both the assembly and the legislative council.

With the Governor's assent, the amendment is now in effect, providing an additional year of service for judicial officers in the state. This move aligns with the government's efforts to optimize the judiciary's experience and expertise for a longer period.

Even Journalists were Not...

TPN, Vijayawada: Andhra Pradesh Minister Nadendla Manohar alleged that rice meant for the poor through the Civil Supplies Department was smuggled and exported abroad during the previous government's tenure. He stated that these irregularities were carried out openly from Kakinada port over five years. The minister further claimed that the port was kept under strict control, barring access to journalists and the general public. Speaking to the media in Vijayawada on Sunday, he criticized the previous ycp government for allegedly misusing Rs. 12,800 crore allocated for ration rice, preventing it from reaching the poor. Minister Nadendla stated that after the formation of the coalition government, raids were conducted on illegal rice stocks. In the last week of June, inspections in 13 warehouses in Kakinada revealed 25,000 tons of ration rice. The minister emphasized that special attention was focused on Kakinada port, noting that more exports were conducted from this port in the last five years than from any other port in the state. He alleged the creation of a "green channel" for smuggling, wherein ration rice was collected from villages and exported abroad via Kakinada port.

He revealed that only 20 security personnel were stationed at the crucial port during the previous government's tenure, which he said jeopardized national security for the benefit of illegal traders. Inspections at the port are being conducted to uncover the individuals behind these irregularities and to determine the extent of illegal trading activities, he explained. He assured the public that the government has taken steps to dismantle the smuggling mafia operating at Kakinada port. The minister recalled that Deputy CM Pawan Kalyan had recently visited the port to investigate the irregularities. He also questioned why former leaders Dwarampudi and Kannababu had remained silent about the illegal activities at the port.

Speculations about Nagababu, Pawan Kalyan's brother, being proposed as a Rajya Sabha candidate were recently dismissed by Nagababu himself, who clarified that he is not interested in holding any position of power and prefers to support his leader from the sidelines. With this development, Janasena's decision to refrain from contesting the Rajya Sabha elections aligns with the party's strategy of consolidating its influence for the future. Analysts believe that the party might aim for stronger representation in upcoming elections as more Rajya Sabha seats become available when the terms of current YSRCP MPs end. The unexpected turn of events—two former YSRCP leaders being poised to secure Rajya Sabha seats under the NDA banner—has raised eyebrows. This political realignment signals a shift in power dynamics within the state, setting the stage for TDP and BJP to strengthen their foothold in Andhra Pradesh's political landscape.

AP Govt Issues Orders on...

TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The Andhra Pradesh government has taken a significant decision regarding the AP Waqf Board. The Waqf Board, appointed by the previous YSRCP government, has been dissolved. Orders to this effect were issued on Saturday. State Law and Minority Welfare Minister NMD Farooq stated that the current coalition government has withdrawn the controversial GO-47 issued during the previous government's tenure.

The Minority Welfare Department has now issued GO-75, revoking the earlier GO. Minister Farooq recalled that on October 21 last year, the then government faced legal challenges in the state High Court over the manner in which members of the Waqf Board were nominated. The High Court had issued an interim order staying the selection process of the Waqf Board Chairman.

Minister Farooq explained that due to various legal issues, the Waqf Board experienced an administrative vacuum. To address this, the coalition government issued a new GO-75, which annuls the previous controversial GO.

Shock to Village Secretariat Staff - Govt Latest Orders!



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The AP government is making key decisions as it prepares a new action plan for the management of ward and village secretariats, which were established during the YSRCP regime. Steps are being taken to link village secretariats with panchayats, and significant changes regarding staff management are underway. As part of these changes, the latest orders issued by the government have come as a shock to ward and village secretariat employees.

The government has issued show-cause notices to ward and village secretariat staff. The government considers the timely distribution of pensions on the first day of every month as a prestigious task. This month, as the first day fell on a Sunday, the government decided to distribute pensions on Saturday itself. Secretariat staff were tasked with continuing the pension distribution coalition, previously handled by volunteers, and were ordered to begin distributions early in the morning.

However, show-cause notices were issued to staff for failing to complete the pension distribution within the stipulated time. The staff expressed grievances, stating that technical issues had prevented them from logging in, despite meeting their targets. Additionally, the government has issued fresh guidelines regarding attendance. From now on, staff at every secretariat must record both their arrival and departure times in the attendance mobile app. Failure to log attendance both times will result in the employee being marked on leave for the day.

Previously, employees were required to log attendance only once when entering or leaving the secretariat. The new guidelines mandate attendance for every instance of entry and exit, adding pressure on the staff. The lack of volunteer recruitment has further increased the workload on secretariat employees.

Furthermore, it seems certain that village secretariats will be linked to panchayats. Officials are planning to reallocate secretariat staff based on requirements, attaching the surplus staff to various government departments. A final decision on these changes is expected to be made in the next cabinet meeting.

Alert for AP - Heavy Rains and Flash Floods Expected in Several Districts!



TPN, Andhra Pradesh: The impact of the cyclone is being felt in Andhra Pradesh, with heavy rains lashing three districts. Torrential rains are also continuing in Tirumala, and reservoirs are nearing full capacity. The Meteorological Department has issued a fresh warning that heavy rains will persist in several districts of AP for the next two days, even after the cyclone has crossed the coast. An alert has been issued for the possibility of flash floods in three districts. The state government is closely monitoring the situation and issuing necessary instructions to officials.

The cyclone crossed the coast near Puducherry on Saturday night, as announced by the Disaster Management Agency. However, its impact is being felt in Andhra Pradesh. Heavy rains are forecast for today and tomorrow in parts of the south coast and Rayalaseema regions. Officials have warned of heavy rainfall in Nellore, Annamayya, Tirupati, Chittoor, and Sri Sathya Sai districts over the next two days. An alert for flash floods has also been issued for Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, and YSR districts.

Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea due to the heavy rains, and farmers are urged to take necessary precautions. Intense rainfall continues to affect Nellore and Chittoor districts, while Tirupati and Tirumala are experiencing torrential downpours. In Tirumala, devotees are facing challenges due to landslides on the walking path. However, thanks to the measures taken by TTD, the movement of devotees has been managed without any accidents.

In Tirumala, areas around the Srivari temple, Mada Streets, Akhilandam, Annaprasada Bhavan, Vaikuntam Queue Complex, roads, cottages, bus stand, and parks are soaked and muddy due to the relentless rains. A large number of devotees have been forced to remain confined to their accommodations due to the adverse weather conditions. The government and local authorities continue to monitor the situation and ensure the safety of all affected residents and devotees.

Six Months In: AP Moves **Ahead Without Volunteers**

TPN, Avinash: It's been half a year to-door delivery, the key responsibility since the new government assumed power in Andhra Pradesh, following a resounding electoral mandate. The decisive rejection of the previous YSR Congress governance has placed the responsibility squarely on Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu to reform systems and eliminate inefficiencies, one of which appears to be the controversial volunteer network introduced under YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's tenure. The volunteer system, initially designed to facilitate welfare program deliveries, was widely criticized as a political tool benefiting the ruling party. Despite its prevalence during Jagan's regime, Naidu has refrained from explicitly addressing its continuation or dismissal. Instead, he has allowed public services, like pension distribution, to function without their involvement. This subtle move seems aimed at demonstrating that the system can operate efficiently without volunteers, saving public funds.

In the past six months, six rounds of pension distributions have taken place without volunteer participation. Doorof volunteers, has proceeded seamlessly without their involvement. As of November 30th, pensions were distributed a day early, with 91.63% disbursed by 2 PM. This success raises questions about the necessity of retaining the volunteer network.

Critics argue that the volunteer system is a misuse of resources, offering low salaries for largely unproductive roles. The numbers tell the story—out of the original 2,63,000 volunteers, 1,07,000 resigned ahead of the elections to campaign for the YSR Congress. Currently, only 1,10,000 remain, many of whom are reportedly seeking or securing better employment opportunities elsewhere.

As the new government prioritizes efficient governance and cost-effective measures, the future of the volunteer system remains uncertain. With its apparent redundancy and diminishing workforce, many are questioning whether this chapter of governance in Andhra Pradesh should be permanently closed.

CID Files Affidavit Opposing Bail to IPS Officers



- IPS officers file anticipatory bail petitions

TPN, Vijayawada: The Andhra Pradesh High Court held a hearing regarding the case of Mumbai actress Kadambari Jethwani. The CID submitted an affidavit opposing the grant of bail to the IPS officers facing charges in the case. The CID appealed to the court not to grant bail to Kantirana Tata and Vishal Gunni. Along with these officers, several policemen and a lawyer have also filed petitions seeking anticipatory bail.

In this context, the CID filed an affidavit stating that individuals responsible for upholding the law were instead involved in abuse of power. The affidavit alleged that actress Kadambari Jethwani was illegally arrested under orders from the then Intelligence Chief. It further claimed that the former Commissioner of Police, Kantirana Tata, had arranged flight tickets to Mumbai as part of the alleged operation.

The CID emphasized that granting bail could hinder the investigation and potentially derail its progress. Meanwhile, the High Court has scheduled the hearing for the anticipatory bail petitions on Monday.

This situation causes significant inconvenience to those traveling to Tirumala.

Passengers are requesting the South Central Railway authorities to take immediate steps to address this issue and prevent water stagnation in the vicinity of Renigunta railway station. Busting Myths About Women in the Military: The Need for Inclusivity and Equal Leadership

Rajeev Puri, outgoing Corps Commander of 17 Corps, regarding women Commanding Officers (COs) reflect a broader issue within the military: the resistance to women assuming leadership roles in traditionally male-dominated spaces. In his five-page letter to the Army Headquarters, Gen Puri criticized what he called the "exaggerated tendency to complain" and "misplaced sense of entitlement" of women COs, attributing their behavior to an over-ambitious desire to prove themselves in roles historically dominated by men. Such generalizations not only undermine the competence and potential of women leaders but also ignore the changing dynamics of modern warfare and the military's increasing focus on intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (ISR) rather than brute physical strength.

2007 provides critical insights into the integration of women in military units. Their study of mixed-gender training in Israel's military showed that men and women exhibited similar operational suitability in high-tech warfare. Yet, the masculine ideal of the soldier, particularly in combat roles, continues to dominate military culture. This adherence

The recent concerns raised by Lt Gen to outdated gender norms in the Indian military's conception of a soldier leads to unnecessary discrimination against women, despite the evolving nature of modern conflict, which relies increasingly on technology, intelligence, and strategy rather than sheer physical prowess.

The notion that mixed-gender units are less effective due to a lack of "male bonding" has been dismantled by numerous studies, including one conducted by the U.S. Army Research Institute in 1995. This study concluded that military performance is more closely tied to a unit's commitment to common goals rather than interpersonal relationships. Further research by scholars such as Robert MacCoun and Aaron Belkin supports this argument, emphasizing that cohesion is built on shared objectives, not on gender-based bonds. Moreover, In this context, the research of Orna Leora Rosen's research suggests that the Sassoon-Levy and Sarit Amram-Katz in inclusion of women can have a positive impact on a unit's overall effectiveness, highlighting the necessity of accepting women in military roles for the sake of enhanced operational efficiency.

> Research from the Norwegian Defense Department, which conducted a study on the reasons women leave the military, found that a male-dominated, ex

clusionary military culture was a significant factor driving women away. Such a culture is not only detrimental to women's participation but also harms the military's ability to retain talent and reduce attrition rates. The Indian military, lacking similar studies on gender inclusion, can still draw valuable lessons from global research to foster a more inclusive environment that supports the leadership potential of wom-

In operational terms, including more women in leadership positions could also improve security outcomes in conflict zones. For example, the relative calm periods in Kashmir are often attributed to successful peacebuilding measures, such as reducing local recruitment into insurgent groups through intelligence gathering and community engagement. The presence of women in conflict zones, as seen in UN peacekeeping operations, can enhance intelligence networks due to the increased access they have to local populations, particularly women, who are often sidelined in highly militarized areas. Lt Gen Kirsten Lund, the first female Force Commander in a UN peacekeeping mission, emphasized that women soldiers have access to 100% of the population, a crucial advantage in conflict zones.

How Media Played Mani Shankar Aiyar in Maharashtra Elections

A critical look at the results of certain constituencies demonstrates how this fragmentation of the Muslim vote impacted election outcomes. In Aurangabad East, where Muslims form more than 37 percent of the electorate, the vote was split between multiple Muslim candidates, leading to the defeat of the All India Majlis-e-Ittehad-ul-Musli-



meen (AIMIM) state president Imtiaz Jaleel, a former MP. Jaleel lost by a narrow margin of 2,161 votes to the BJP's Atul Save. Jaleel secured 91,113 votes, while Save garnered 93,274. The division of Muslim votes further deepened with Afsar Khan from the Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA) and Samajwadi Party's Abdul Ghaffar Syed, who earned 6,507 and 5,943 votes respectively. This fragmentation proved detrimental to Jaleel's chances, and Save's victory became a symbol of how split votes can affect electoral outcomes.


Similarly, in constituencies like Aurangabad Central, where the Muslim electorate is significant, the splintering of votes among multiple Muslim candidates affected the overall political landscape. This trend of divided voting was not an isolated occurrence but was evident in several constituencies where Muslim candidates from different parties drew votes away from each other, allowing BJP candidates to clinch unexpected

China's New Strategy: Poaching Talent to Bypass IPR Violations and Boost Tech Capabilities

In an attempt to acquire cutting-edge technology and expertise, China has adopted a strategy of poaching key talent from Western companies, bypassing the usual methods of intellectual property rights (IPR) violations such as hacking and espionage. This shift in approach is exemplified by Chinese technology giant Huawei's recent efforts to recruit employees from top semiconductor firms like Zeiss SMT, which produces vital components for the semiconductor industry.

Historically, Chinese hackers have been known for their brute-force tactics, breaking through complex software codes and stealing intellectual property. However, Huawei and other Chinese companies have recently realized that they can achieve their goals more discreetly by using time-tested tactics: headhunting. By offering enormous salaries—sometimes three times the current pay—Huawei has successfully lured disgruntled or ambitious employees from key players in the semiconductor industry. These employees are often tempted by the promise of a huge financial windfall, despite the risks of violating confidentiality agreements and corporate loyalty. Once enticed by such lucrative offers, employees may unintentionally or knowingly reveal trade secrets, contributing to China's technology advancement without direct violations of intellectual property laws.

The strategy of poaching has been particularly effective in the semiconductor sector, where



high-level expertise is essential for the development of advanced technology. The global semiconductor industry, which includes companies based in the U.S., Europe, and Taiwan, has faced increasing pressure from China's attempts to secure top talent. In fact, the Chinese approach has reached such an extent that even Taiwan, the world's largest producer of semiconductors, has experienced Huawei's overtures to recruit its employees. To avoid detection, China often uses intermediaries seemingly innocuous local companies—to approach potential targets, keeping their activities under the radar of Western authorities.

This new approach has sparked alarm among Western governments and corporations. For instance, German intelligence agencies have investigated attempts by Huawei to lure employees of Zeiss SMT, a leading producer of semiconductor components.

This move is part of the party's strategy to secure a greater influence within the state government, particularly as it seeks to hold onto significant ministerial portfolios.

On the other side, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is facing internal discussions regarding the distribution of key positions. Devendra Fadnavis, the BJP leader and former CM, is the frontrunner for the CM's position. However, Fadnavis is reportedly reluctant to relinquish the Home ministry, a powerful and strategic portfolio he has previously held. The Home ministry's control is crucial to the state's political landscape, and Fadnavis's hesitance to give it up adds a layer of complexity to the ongoing negotiations.

In the previous government, Eknath Shinde served as the Chief Minister, while Devendra Fadnavis and Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) leader Sharad Pawar held the positions of Deputy CMs. Fadnavis was responsible for the Home ministry, while Pawar oversaw Finance, marking a unique power-sharing arrangement that balanced the interests of the Shiv Sena, BJP, and NCP.



India's Economy Faces Challenges: Rahul Gandhi Calls for New Thinking

As India's GDP slumped to a near twoyear low of 5.4% in the July-September quarter, Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, called for a shift in economic strategies. The downturn, attributed to poor performance in the manufacturing and mining sectors, as well as weak consumption, has prompted Gandhi to emphasize the need for a fresh approach to boost the nation's economy.

Official data revealed that the economy is facing substantial challenges, with growth figures marking a slowdown not seen in two years. The decline has raised concerns about the long-term stability of key industries and the welfare of the general population. In light of these figures, Gandhi argued that India's economic policies need to be rethought, with a focus on creating an equitable and sustainable growth model. Speaking on the issue, Gandhi pointed out the growing disparity in the distribution of economic benefits. He argued that the current economic framework is failing to uplift the vast majority of the population, including farmers, laborers, and the middle class, while a small group of billionaires continue to accumulate wealth. Kejriwal Accuses BJP of Inaction on Law and Order, Claims Attack Orchestrated

AAP national convenor and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Sunday criticized the BJP-led central government for its alleged inaction on law and order issues in Delhi. He claimed that instead of addressing the growing security concerns in the city, the central government orchestrated an attack on him during his November visit to Gujarat.

Speaking at a press conference, Kejriwal addressed the incident in which a liquid was thrown at him, describing it as "harmless" but potentially dangerous. He pointed out that this was the third attack on him within a span of just 35 days, expressing concern over his personal safety and the overall security situation in Delhi. Despite the attack, Kejriwal emphasized that his focus remained on the deteriorating law and order in the capital, rather than engaging in political gamesmanship.

Kejriwal's remarks came amidst mounting tensions between the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and the BJP. The Delhi CM accused the central government, led by Home Minister Amit Shah and the BJP, of targeting him personally instead of addressing the root causes of crime and lawlessness in the city. He also claimed that instead of acting against criminals, the BJP had arrested one of his party's legislators, further intensifying the political standoff between the two parties.

While Kejriwal has consistently raised alarms about the deteriorating security conditions in Delhi, his criticism now extends to the alleged political motivations behind the attacks on him. He argued that the BJP's focus on silencing him, rather than addressing the city's security challenges, reflects the central government's inability to effectively manage law and order.



Devendra Fadnavis Set to Succeed Eknath Shinde as Maharashtra CM

Amid ongoing uncertainty over the successor to Eknath Shinde as Chief Minister of Maharashtra, a senior BJP leader confirmed on Sunday that Devendra Fadnavis has been finalised as the new CM. The leader, speaking anonymously to news agency PTI, added that a BJP legislature party meeting will be held on either December 2 or 3 to formalize the decision.

Fadnavis, who served as the deputy CM in the outgoing Shinde-led government, has held the position of CM twice before, with his second stint lasting only a few days. His name had been circulating for the top position for some time, and this announcement is expected to bring clarity to the ongoing leadership suspense.

BJP leader Sudhir Mungantiwar also confirmed the upcoming meeting, stating that it would be held to select the parliamentary leader. "The representatives from the centre will bring the names forward. Once selected, the announcement will be made ahead of the oath ceremony," Mungantiwar said.

Meanwhile, caretaker Deputy CM Ajit Pawar had also remarked that during a Mahayuti leaders' meeting in Delhi, it was decided that the next CM would be from the BJP. Eknath Shinde, in a separate statement, reassured that unity remained strong among the Mahayuti allies. He added that the decision on the CM candidate would be made soon, emphasizing that he had already extended his "unconditional support" to the choice of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, and BJP President JP Nadda.

As tensions mount over the leadership transition, all eyes are now on the official announcement, which is expected in the coming days, ahead of the new CM's swearing-in ceremony.



Will you now demolish Red Fort, Taj Mahal, Gol Gumbaz: Kharge to Hindutva outfits

Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge on Sunday raised concerns over RSS Chief Mohan Bhagwat's recent statement urging people not to look for a 'Shivling' in every mosque. Kharge questioned whether Bhagwat's remarks were a case of double-speak and suggested that Hindutva outfits might now target iconic landmarks such as the Red Fort, Taj Mahal, Qutub Minar, and Charminar.

Kharge made the comments during the 'Save Constitution Rally' where he voiced his skepticism over the growing influence of Hindut-va groups in the country. He also pointed to a potential link between an oral observation by the then Chief Justice of India and the rise in demands from these groups for surveying mosques in search of temple remnants. Kharge implied that the judicial statement, which led to the surveys of mosque premises in Sambhal (Uttar Pradesh) and Ajmer (Rajasthan) in recent weeks, had fueled controversy and created a tense law-and-order situation in various parts of the country.

The surveys sparked widespread debates and protests, with critics arguing that such actions were attempts to stoke communal tensions by revisiting sensitive historical issues. Kharge's remarks underscored the ongoing friction surrounding religious symbols and heritage sites, which have become a focal point for Hindutva groups advocating for the reassertion of Hindu identity.

Kharge's statements also came at a time when Congress reaffirmed its "firm commitment" to protecting the Constitution and safeguarding India's pluralistic fabric. The party has been vocal in opposing the BJP's policies, particularly those linked to religious polarization and the role of Hindutva in national politics. By raising these concerns, Kharge has once again underscored the Congress' stance against efforts that may challenge India's secular principles.

As tensions escalate over the ongoing surveys and their potential consequences, Kharge's remarks reflect broader anxieties about the direction of political discourse and the preservation of India's constitutional values amidst increasing religious divisiveness.





Taiwan President Lai Ching-te Receives Warm Welcome in Hawaii

Taiwan President Lai Ching-te was greeted with a red carpet, flower garlands, and warm "alohas" as he arrived in Hawaii on Saturday for a twoday stopover, part of a broader Pacific tour. This visit marks the first time a Taiwanese president has been accorded such a welcome in Hawaii, according to his office. The reception in Honolulu stands in stark contrast to the fiery rhetoric from Beijing, which strongly condemns any recognition of Taiwan as a sovereign state.

China claims Taiwan as part of its territory, and Lai's overseas trip, which includes stops in the Pacific island nations that recognize Taiwan, has triggered threats from Beijing. China's foreign ministry issued a statement condemning the United States for facilitating Lai's visit, asserting that the US has "seriously violated" China's sovereignty and territorial integrity. Beijing warned it would take "resolute



and strong measures" to defend its claims.

During his time in Hawaii, Lai, dressed

casually in a Hawaiian shirt, visited several significant sites, including a Pacific island history museum, an emergency management center, and the USS Arizona Memorial in Pearl Harbor. He was met by Hawaii Governor Josh Green and Ingrid Larson, managing director of the American Institute in Taiwan, among other dignitaries. Throughout his visit, he was presented with traditional Hawaiian leis and other local gifts, symbolizing the warm ties between Taiwan and the US.

Lai's trip continues Taiwan's push to expand its global partnerships, particularly with its diplomatic allies in the Pacific region. Following his stop in Hawaii, he is scheduled to visit the Marshall Islands, Tuvalu, and Palau, the only Pacific island nations that officially recognize Taiwan's sovereignty. His itinerary also includes a brief stop in Guam.

In a statement before departure, Lai emphasized Taiwan's commitment to democracy, peace, and prosperity, stating that his trip aimed to strengthen international cooperation based on shared values. "We are all Team Taiwan," he said, reaffirming the island's collaborative approach to expanding its global presence.

Lai's visit comes at a time of heightened military tension, with China regularly conducting military drills near Taiwan. Despite Beijing's warnings, the Taiwanese government remains steadfast in its pursuit of international recognition and continues to strengthen ties with the US, its most important ally. Taiwan's security is bolstered by US military support, and Lai's visit coincided with the approval of a \$385 million US arms deal for Taiwan, which includes spare parts for F-16s and radar systems.



Indian-American Kash Patel Nominated As FBI Director By Donald Trump

US President-elect Donald Trump has nominated Indian-American Pentagon official Kashyap "Kash" Patel as the new FBI Director, a move that signals his intent to radically reshape the nation's top law enforcement agency. Patel, a staunch Trump ally, has been a vocal critic of the FBI's operations, especially its investigations into Trump and his associates. His nomination highlights Trump's dissatisfaction with the current FBI leadership under Christopher Wray, whom he appointed in 2017.

In a post on his social media platform, Truth Social, Trump praised Patel, calling him a "brilliant lawyer, investigator, and 'America First' fighter" who has dedicated his career to exposing corruption and defending justice. Trump also highlighted Patel's pivotal role in challenging the so-called "Russia Hoax," referring to the FBI's investigation into alleged Russian interference in the 2016 presidential election.

Patel, 44, has been outspoken about his desire to overhaul the FBI. In a recent interview with conservative podcaster Shawn Ryan, Patel outlined plans to dismantle what he perceives as the FBI's "deep state" elements, particularly its intelligence operations. "I'd break that component out of it. I'd shut down the FBI Hoover building on day one and reopen it the next day as a museum of the deep state," Patel said. He proposed sending thousands of FBI agents out across America to focus purely on law enforcement duties, rather than intelligence gathering.

This radical proposal aligns with Trump's ongoing criticisms of the FBI, particularly its handling of the investigation into classified documents found at Trump's Mar-a-Lago estate. The search, conducted under Wray's leadership, enraged Trump and his supporters, further fueling his calls for changes at the FBI.



The protests, which have continued for three consecutive nights, have been met with heavy police force, including the use of water cannons and tear gas.

Putin approves military focused 2025-2027 Budget

Russian President Vladimir Putin has approved a new state budget for the years 2025-2027, which prioritizes military spending amid the ongoing conflict in Ukraine. According to a document published on Russia's official legal acts website on Sunday, the budget will feature a 25 percent increase in military expenditure, reflecting the country's heightened defense needs. However, the new budget will also be one of the most secretive in post-Soviet history, with nearly a third of the total spending concealed from public view.

The government has emphasized that military needs, particularly those related to the ongoing "special military operation" in Ukraine, will remain the main priority for national spending. Moscow continues to allocate significant resources to support its military efforts, and the latest budget shows a clear commitment to maintaining and even expanding defense capabilities in the face of continued international pressure and sanctions. The Russian leadership has justified these increases as necessary for national security and the defense of Russian sovereignty.



In addition to military funding, the budget also includes provisions for social needs and technological development. These areas have been earmarked as critical for maintaining internal stability and securing Russia's long-term economic future. However, the substantial increase in defense spending has raised concerns among critics who argue that it could come at the expense of other vital sectors such as healthcare, education, and infrastructure.

The budget's secrecy is also notable. Nearly a third of the total budget has been classified, with details about the allocation of funds for specific military projects and operations kept hidden from the public. Bangaldesh Court Acquits All In 2004 Attack On Sheikh Hasina's Rally Case

In a significant ruling on Sunday, the Bangladesh High Court overturned the verdict of a lower court, acquitting all 49 individuals convicted in connection with the 2004 grenade attack on a rally led by Sheikh Hasina, the current Prime Minister of Bangladesh. Among those acquitted were Tarique Rahman, son of former Prime Minister Khaleda Zia, and Lutfozzaman Babar, a former state minister.

The grenade attack, which took place on August 21, 2004, targeted an Awami League rally in Dhaka's Bangabandhu Avenue, leaving 24

people dead and nearly 300 others injured. The attack occurred while Hasina, then an opposition leader, was addressing the crowd at a rally against terrorism. Despite narrowly escaping the assassination attempt, Hasina and her party faced a profound political crisis.

The High Court's bench, consisting of Justice AKM Asaduzzaman and Justice Syed Enayet Hossain, ruled that the trial court's judgment was "illegal" and annulled the verdicts. The



judgment comes after reviewing death references and appeals related to the attack. The case had initially relied heavily on a confessional statement from Mufti Abdul Hannan, the leader of the banned militant group Harkat-ul-Jihad al-Islami (HuJI). However, the High Court deemed the confession inadmissible, ruling it was extracted under duress and lacked proper legal examination.

In the original 2018 trial court decision, 19 individuals, including Babar, were sentenced to death, while Tarique Rahman and 19 others received life sentences. However, the defense team for the accused argued that no specific allegations had been made against their clients, leading to their request for the High Court to overturn the lower court's verdict. On the other hand, prosecutors urged the High Court to uphold the convictions, stating that the evidence against the accused was overwhelming.

India's Coal **Production Sees** 7.2% Growth in November



Tndia's coal production grew by 7.2% in November, reach-Ling 90.62 million tonnes (MT) compared to 84.52 MT in the same month last year, according to a statement from the Ministry of Coal released on Sunday.

The country's coal output from April to November this fiscal year also showed a positive trend, rising by 6.21% to 628.03 MT from 591.32 MT during the same period in 2023, based on provisional figures. This increase in production reflects the government's ongoing efforts to ensure a steady supply of coal for energy generation and other sectors.

In November 2024, coal production from captive and other entities saw a significant rise, reaching 17.13 MT, up from 12.44 MT in November 2023. This surge highlights the growth in coal output from both public and private sector players, contributing to the overall increase in national coal production.

Coal dispatches also showed steady improvement, with 85.22 MT dispatched in November, compared to 82.07 MT in the same month last year, reflecting a growth of 3.85%. This increase in coal dispatches is crucial for meeting the energy demand, especially with the ongoing energy transition and the need to secure adequate fuel supplies for power plants and industries across the country.

The rise in coal production and dispatches comes as part of India's broader strategy to meet its growing energy needs, particularly in the wake of increasing electricity demand during the winter season. The government has been focusing on ramping up domestic coal production to reduce reliance on imports and enhance energy security.

As India continues to pursue its energy goals, the coal sector's performance remains key to supporting the country's industrial activities and electricity generation capacity.

India's GDP Growth Slows to 5.4% in Q2; Crisil Revises 2024-25 Forecast to 6.8%

Tndia's **I**growth has shown signs of slowing, with the country's GDP expanding by just 5.4% in the July-September quarter of the financial year 2024-25. This marks a significant decline from the 8.1% growth seen during the same period last year and falls short of the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) forecast of 7%. Following this weaker-than-expected performance, credit rating agency Crisil has revised its full-year GDP growth forecast to 6.8%, down from an earlier estimate of 7.2%.



The slowdown is attributed to a combination of factors, including high interest rates and a lack of fiscal stimulus. Crisil noted that risks remain tilted toward the downside due to the disappointing second-quarter performance. However, some high-frequency indicators from October, such as robust automobile sales and export growth, suggest a potential revival in the third quarter, raising hopes that the current slowdown may be temporary.

Agriculture, however, offers a silver lining. The sector's growth has improved, with expectations of a strong kharif harvest, driven by favorable monsoon conditions and higher reservoir levels. Crisil anticipates that agricultural growth will continue to boost rural incomes and consumption. Additionally, as kharif crops begin to enter

the market, food inflation pressures are expected to ease, which could help alleviate the cost of living for both rural and urban households.

On the inflation front, retail inflation stood at 6.21% in October, exceeding the RBI's upper tolerance limit of 6%. This rise in inflation was primarily driven by higher food prices, particularly for vegetables, fruits, and oils. Despite these inflationary pressures, Crisil suggests that easing food prices, combined with the festive and wedding season, may provide a boost to consumption in the second half of the fiscal year.

The RBI has maintained an elevated repo rate of 6.5% to curb inflation, with policymakers hoping to bring it down to a more sustainable 4% target in the long term.

GST Collections Hit ₹1.82 Trillion in November, **Driven by Festive Demand**

Tndia's Goods and Ser-**⊥**vices Tax (GST) collections reached ₹1.82 trillion in November, marking an 8.5% yearon-year growth, according to official data released on Sunday. The figures highlight a strong boost in tax receipts driven by increased consumption during the festive season.

Policymakers are optimistic about sustained growth in both rural and urban consumption. In its latest monthly economic review, the Ministry of Finance noted that India's economic momentum showed signs of revival in October, supported by indicators like the Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) and increased e-way bill generation. These signals ing ₹13,253 crore. suggest a recovery in demand across both ru-



ects an 11.6% growth in total GST collections to ₹10.6 trillion for the fiscal year. MS Mani, a partner at Deloitte India, commented that domestic GST revenue growth of over 10% in FY25 supports a forecasted GDP growth of 7%. He added that collections in the first eight months of FY 25 had already exceeded ₹1 trillion more than the same period in FY 2024, surpassing budget estimates for the fiscal vear.

Mentioned in texts ranging from Virgil's *Aeneid* to Alexandre Dumas' *Le Corricolo*, and Pellegrino Artusi's influential 1890 cookbook *La Scienza in Cucina e l'Arte di Mangiar Bene* (Science in the Kitchen and the Art of Eating Well), pizza has made its mark in literature across centuries.

Today, pizza is one of the most beloved foods globally, available in a multitude of forms and variations

across different cultures. However, the earliest pizzas were simple flatbreads, topped with mushrooms and herbs, lacking the tomato sauce and cheese we associate with modern pizza. These flatbreads were often sold to people who couldn't afford plates, serving as both the meal and the dishware. In Virgil's *Aeneid*, after Aeneas and his companions arrive in Latium, they sit under a tree and eat "thin wheaten cakes" as platters for their meal, topping them with mushrooms and herbs. The scene ends with Aeneas' son, Ascanius, exclaiming: "Look! We've even eaten our plates!"

The pizza we recognize today — specifically the thin-crust Neapolitan version, not the



unusual momos-topped variants from some fast-food chains — was born in Naples during the late 18th century. Under Bourbon rule, Naples became one of Europe's largest cities, home to a large population of impoverished peasants known as the *lazzaroni* due to their ragged appearance, likened to Lazarus. These laborers, porters, and messengers needed inexpensive, portable food. This demand led to the creation of pizza, with its simple toppings suited for quick, affordable meals on the go.

Thus, pizza evolved from humble beginnings as a flatbread snack into the iconic dish enjoyed worldwide today, with a legacy deeply embedded in both literature and culture.


Harvard Researchers Create Robots Powered by Vodka, Inspired by Cheerios in Milk Researchers at Harvard University have Runveiled a groundbreaking innovation in

robotics-robots powered by vodka. Drawing inspiration from the way Cheerios stick together in milk, these robots utilize the Marangoni effect, a physical phenomenon where liquids with varying surface tensions create motion, to move across water without the need for motors or batteries.

The Marangoni effect occurs when two liquids with different surface tensions interact, creating a flow of liquid from areas of high tension to low tension. In this case, the researchers used vodka, which has a lower surface tension compared to water. When vodka is introduced to water, it creates a dynamic force that propels these robots across the water's surface. By carefully controlling the amount and placement of vodka, the robots move in a precise and controlled manner.

This unique method of movement opens up exciting possibilities for future applications. One major potential benefit lies in environmental cleanup. These robots could be deployed to clean up oil spills or other contaminants in water, where their ability to move autonomously without the need for power sources like motors or batteries makes them ideal for delicate and hard-to-reach environments.

In addition to environmental applications, the technology could have significant implications in medical delivery systems. Robots that move using




