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## Allu Arjun Unfairly Cornered; Collective Accountability is Needed



**TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad :** Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan has addressed the controversy surrounding the arrest of actor Allu Arjun and the stampede at Sandhya Theater during the 'Pushpa 2' premiere on December 4. Speaking to media in Mangalagiri, Pawan Kalyan shared his perspective on the incident, emphasizing the importance of fairness and accountability.

Speaking to the media in Mangalagiri, he admitted to not knowing the complete details of the incident, saying, "I don't know what happened in front of or behind the scenes in the Bunny case." Defending the police, Pawan stated that the law applies equally to everyone and emphasized their role in ensuring security during such events. He also acknowledged the emotional connection actors have with their fans, remarking, "Every hero has the right to greet their fans and feel their reaction."

Pawan Kalyan stated that either the team or the hero should have visited the victim's family the day after the incident, emphasizing the importance of showing immediate support in such situations. He further stressed that the theater management and the actor's team should have taken adequate precautions to avoid the tragic incident. The Deputy CM called for collective accountability, urging all parties involved to ensure such mishaps are prevented in the future.

Pawan Kalyan also drew a comparison to his brother Chiranjeevi, who used to attend movie screenings incognito to avoid disruptions. "Chiranjeevi garu would watch films in theaters wearing a mask to maintain a low profile," he said. Addressing ticket pricing policies, Pawan contrasted the approach taken by Telangana CM Revanth Reddy, praising him for providing opportunities to increase ticket prices for benefit shows in Telangana, unlike YCP policies in Andhra Pradesh. Concluding his remarks, the Deputy CM expressed disappointment over how Allu Arjun was "unfairly cornered" in the issue, reiterating that such incidents call for collective accountability rather than isolating any individual.

## KTR Accuses Congress of Misleading Farmers and BCs

**KTR Slams Congress for Failing to Deliver on Promises  
Telangana Government Against Corruption Claims  
KTR Discusses Party Strengthening Plans for 2025**

**TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad :** K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) strongly criticized the Congress government led by Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, accusing it of filing baseless cases and failing to deliver on key promises. KTR addressed various issues, including corruption allegations, government policies, and political strategies, while highlighting the Congress party's shortcomings.

KTR dismissed the cases filed against him as baseless, claiming they were politically motivated and lacked evidence. "The government files cases in the name of the Anti-Corruption Bureau when there is no corruption. Even if they file indiscriminately, we will face them legally," KTR stated, adding that he has approached the High Court to quash the FIR against him.

Addressing allegations related to the Formula E race in Hyderabad, KTR defended the government's decision to support the event financially. "We paid to ensure Hyderabad and Telangana maintained their international reputation. Not a single rupee of corruption occurred in this



affair," he asserted.

KTR also questioned the Congress party's inconsistencies, citing that CM Revanth Reddy had withheld details of his meeting with Formula E representatives for over a year. He accused the Congress government of blackmailing officials and lying about financial matters, including allegations of misappropriating Rs. 600 crores.

KTR criticized the Congress government

for its failure to implement key promises, particularly the farmer loan waiver scheme. He alleged that delays and inefficiencies in the program led to farmer suicides and financial chaos, stating, "The state's farmers have lost Rs. 26,000 crore due to the Congress party's negligence."

He further accused the Congress of misleading BC communities by failing to implement 42% local body reservations. "The Congress is using court cases as an excuse to deny BC reservations. This is a conspiracy to deceive marginalized communities," KTR remarked. KTR also criticized CM Revanth Reddy for targeting film personalities, calling it a distraction from public issues. He urged the government to prioritize compensation for victims of recent tragedies, including Gurukul school students and auto drivers.

"The Congress party has proven why people shouldn't vote for them. Their vague promises have become a curse for the state," KTR concluded, reiterating his commitment to strengthening his party at every level.

## Deputy CM Lauds Manmohan Singh's Contributions

Sanjay further raised suspicions about the relationship between Telangana CM Revanth Reddy and Allu Arjun, suggesting something had gone wrong between them, although neither party

had clarified the situation. He questioned why the issue was being discussed in the Assembly when Revanth Reddy had previously stated that the law would take its course in the Sandhya Theater incident and the case involving Allu Arjun.

Additionally, Bandi Sanjay pointed out that CM Revanth Reddy had prematurely shown Pushpa-3, even before the film's release, and highlighted that it had made Rs. 1,700 crores in revenue and gained national recognition. Sanjay criticized the treatment of Allu Arjun, asserting that many actors in Telangana were overlooked while Allu Arjun was being singled out. He implied that the arrest of the actor might be a diversion from the failure to implement the six guarantees promised to the public.

**TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad :** Union Minister Kishan Reddy criticized Sonia Gandhi for behaving disrespectfully towards PV Narasimha Rao, a Telangana native. He expressed his grief that Telangana's own PV did not receive even the respect that an ordinary Congress party leader deserves. He was furious that Sonia had issued an order preventing PV's last rites from being performed in Delhi, and instead, his body was sent to Hyderabad.

Reddy also acknowledged Manmohan Singh's death as an irreparable loss to the country. He recalled that after taking charge as a Union Minister, he had seen Manmohan Singh in the Rajya Sabha in a wheelchair. He said he had the opportunity to bow to Manmohan Singh many times, praising him for serving as Prime Minister for ten years despite facing immense pressure.

Reddy expressed anger over Congress politicizing the death of Manmohan Singh. He reminded that Prime Minister Modi had promised to establish a memorial for Manmohan Singh, similar to the one created for Atal Bihari Vajpayee. ## CM Taking Credit for KCR's Ring Road Project



**TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad :** Former minister and MLA Vemula Prashanth Reddy accused CM and ministers of spreading falsehoods about the North Regional Ring Road project. He criticized Minister Komatireddy for misleading the public, stating that the current government is falsely taking credit for work done during KCR's tenure. Reddy asserted that the Regional Ring Road project was KCR's vision, designed with foresight, and planned with a budget of Rs. 27,000 crores to connect 14 National Highways around Hyderabad.

Reddy elaborated on the timeline, stating that KCR secured the Center's agreement in 2017 to fund 50% of the land acquisition costs. He recounted meetings with Union Minister Nitin Gadkari in 2018 and 2021 to push for the approval of the project. By December 2021, the Center approved the alignment, and Rs 100 crore was deposited for land acquisition. However, Reddy claimed that in the 13 months since Congress came to power, no money has been spent for land acquisition, despite the earlier progress, with 76% of land acquisition already completed in four districts.

## Judgment on Allu Arjun's Bail Petition to be Delivered on January 3



**TPN Correspondent ,Hyderabad :** Actor Allu Arjun's regular bail petition in connection with the Sandhya Theatre stampede case will be decided by the Nampally court on January 3. The court had earlier heard the case today but postponed its verdict after the government and police lawyers requested additional time to file their counter arguments.

During the hearing on Monday, Allu Arjun's legal team argued that the actor should not be held responsible for the stampede that led to Revathi's tragic death. They contended that the case filed under BNS Section 105 was not applicable to Allu Arjun, as he did not contribute to the incident. They urged the court to grant him bail.

In response, the Chikkadpally police filed a counter petition opposing bail, requesting that Allu Arjun be instructed to cooperate with the ongoing investigation if granted bail. Despite this, there has been speculation that the police department is not pursuing the case with full intensity. Observers believe the issue may resolve positively for Allu Arjun when the final verdict is delivered on January 3.

# Hyderabad Metro Extends Services

## Police Issue Guidelines for New Year Celebrations

**TPN Correspondent , Hyderabad :** Hyderabad Metro Rail has announced extended services for New Year's Eve to accommodate the late-night celebrations. On December 31, metro trains will run past midnight, with the last train departing at 12:30 am to help passengers return home safely after the festivities. All three metro lines—red, blue, and green—will operate extended hours to ensure smooth travel during the celebration.

In a statement shared on X, Hyderabad Metro Rail encouraged commuters to "Ring in the New Year with joy and peace of mind!" It reassured passengers that services would continue until 12:30 am on January 1, ensuring a safe and convenient journey into the New Year.



Typically, Hyderabad Metro operates from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm, but the extended hours on New Year's Eve will help citizens enjoy the celebrations without worrying about transportation.

Meanwhile, the Hyderabad Police have put strict measures in place to ensure public safety during the New Year celebra-

tions. Key guidelines include:

- Drunk Driving Offence: Drivers under the influence may face a fine of Rs 10,000, imprisonment for up to six months, and a possible license suspension of three months or longer.
- Breath Analyzer Tests: Vehicles driven by intoxicated individuals will be confiscated unless accompanied by a sober

- driver with a valid license.
- Noise and Speed Regulations: Motorists are advised not to remove silencers from two-wheelers and to adhere to speed limits to prevent accidents.
- Women's Safety: SHE Teams will be deployed throughout the city to ensure the safety of women.
- Designated Drivers: Partygoers are encouraged to use designated drivers or safe transport options.

Hyderabad Police also emphasized that establishments should display safety guidelines prominently and comply with parking, fire safety, and other regulations. These measures aim to balance festive enjoyment with public safety and order, ensuring that everyone can celebrate responsibly.

## Hyderabad Drug Check: 8 Test Positive for Cocaine, Other Substances



**TPN Correspondent Hyderabad :** In a continued effort to curb drug abuse, the Telangana Anti-Narcotics Bureau (TGANB), in collaboration with Cyberabad police, conducted a drug check during an event in Madhapur on Sunday night, December 29. The operation identified 25 individuals suspected of drug use, with 14 undergoing advanced drug testing. Eight individuals tested positive for substances including THC (found in Ganja), Cocaine, Amphetamine, and Methamphetamine.

The operation used advanced equipment, such as drug detection kits, rapid-result urine and saliva testing kits, and trained narcotics detection dogs. This technology provided immediate and accurate results, leaving no room for evasion.

With New Year celebrations approaching, TGANB announced that similar checks would be conducted at events and parties across Telangana. Strict action will be taken against those found consuming or distributing drugs. Additionally, TGANB instructed pubs and bars to display their drug-free status and enforce a zero-tolerance policy on underage drinking. Violations will lead to legal consequences.

## Cockroaches Found in Chutney at Madhuram Tiffins, Customers Outraged

Recently, cockroaches were found in the chutney served to a customer at Madhuram Tiffins, located at Plot No. 75, KPHB Colony, 9th Phase, Kukatpally. The shocked customer discovered the insects in the chutney and immediately questioned the management, who reportedly responded negligently.

This disturbing incident follows a similar situation where cockroaches, worms, and even rats were found in food at other eateries, including one in Kukatpally. A video of the cockroaches in the chutney has since gone viral, sparking outrage among locals.

The incident raises concerns about food hygiene standards at local eateries, urging authorities to take swift action to ensure the safety and cleanliness of food served to the public.



## Rachakonda Traffic Police Introduce Body Cameras for Officers

## Man Dies After Falling From Building in Jeedimetla



**TPN Correspondent , Hyderabad :** In a tragic incident under Jeedimetla police station limits, a man lost his life after accidentally falling from a building in Essar Nayak Nagar, Qutbullapur.

The deceased, identified as Chenchu Ramanaiah (43), was sitting on the wall of his fourth-floor penthouse while smoking late last night when his cigarette slipped, causing him to lose balance and fall. He suffered severe injuries and died on the spot.

Locals discovered the body on the rocks below early in the morning and immediately informed the police. Chenchu Ramanaiah is survived by his wife and son. According to residents, he was employed at a private company in Bollaram.

Jeedimetla police reached the scene, registered a case, and shifted the body to Gandhi Hospital for postmortem. The incident has left the local community in shock, highlighting the dangers of negligence in high-rise buildings.

Further investigation is underway to determine if there were any other contributing factors to the accident.

# Ministers Urge Strike End for Students' Welfare



**TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad :** Ministers Ponnam Prabhakar and Seethakka have appealed to the nearly 19,500 Sarva Shiksha employees and KGBV teachers, who have been on strike for 25 days, to call off their strike for the welfare of students. The ministers emphasized that the ongoing strike is severely affecting students, particularly those from weaker sections studying in Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBV). Minister Prabhakar urged the employees not to harm

the students by prolonging the strike and promised that their concerns would be addressed.

The Sarva Shiksha employees raised issues regarding job regularization, pay scales, and job security, which they have long been advocating for. Minister Prabhakar assured that the issue had been raised with Union Minister Kishan Reddy, and efforts would be made to bring it to the attention of the central govern-

ment. He also highlighted that the problems faced by Sarva Shiksha employees are national issues.

The ministers proposed a meeting with a sub-committee led by Deputy CM Bati Vikramarka to discuss solutions. They promised that non-financial demands, like maternity leaves and casual leaves, would be addressed, while financial matters would be explored further.

## Kavitha Demands Action on Crimes Against Women



**TPN Correspondent, Nizamabad :** BRS MLC K Kavitha on Monday criticized the Congress government in Telangana for the rise in crimes against women, citing a 10% increase in such offenses. Kavitha pointed out that a rape occurs every third hour and a kidnapping every fifth hour in the state. She emphasized the failure of the Congress government to effectively implement the "SHE Teams" initiative, which was introduced by the previous BRS government to combat crimes against women. She urged Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, who oversees the Home department, to hold a special review meeting on women's safety and take immediate action.

Kavitha also slammed the Congress for neglecting key promises, such as farm loan waivers and monthly financial aid for women. She accused the government of mismanagement, harming farmers, women, and laborers. Kavitha demanded immediate loan waivers for over 1.7 lakh farmers in Nizamabad and Kamareddy districts.

Further, she criticized both Congress and the BJP for neglecting development in Nizamabad, highlighting stalled projects, the absence of a police commissioner, and the lack of funding for local municipalities and Telangana University. She called for transparency on the land resurvey issue and expressed frustration over unaddressed regional needs.

## Tummala Unveils Major Infrastructure Projects for Khammam



**TPN Correspondent, Khammam :** Minister Tummala Nagewara Rao announced a series of significant infrastructure projects for Khammam on December 30, 2024. These include the construction of a single ring road designed to improve connectivity and enable travel to Rajahmundry in just one hour. The project will be modeled after Hyderabad's Outer Ring Road (ORR), providing an enhanced road network for the region.

Additionally, Nagewara Rao confirmed the development of an underground drainage system for Khammampattanam and a cable bridge over the Khammam Munneru River. The government also plans to construct national highways in the area, with key projects aimed at improving accessibility. The Minister highlighted the completion of the Sita Rama Project, which will bring Godavari water to ten constituencies, and announced that the Yatala Kunta Tunnel will be ready by the next Independence Day. A national highway connecting Jaggayya Peta to Vaira and a road from Kothagudem to Bhadrachalam are also on the agenda.

Other ambitious projects include the Seethamma Sagar reservoir, valued at Rs 3,000 crore, and the development of waterways in the Godavari. Nagewara Rao expressed hopes for a railway line connecting Pandurangapuram to Bhadrachalam and potential airways in Kothagudem. These projects are set to boost regional connectivity and development.

## Complaint Filed with ED Against KCR, KTR Over ORR Toll Lease

**TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad :** A complaint has been filed with the Enforcement Directorate (ED) against Telangana Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) and his son, Minister K.T. Rama Rao (KTR), alleging irregularities in the Outer Ring Road (ORR) toll lease during the BRS government's tenure. The complaint, filed by the BC Political



JAC, claims that the IRB company paid bribes in the form of electoral bonds for leasing the ORR.

BC Political JAC Chairman Rachala Yugandhar accused the BRS government of embezzling crores of rupees through this lease deal. According to the complaint, in April 2023, the BRS government leased the ORR to the IRB company for 30 years. Later, in July 2023, the company allegedly purchased electoral bonds worth Rs. 25 crore from the

BRS party. Yugandhar called for a thorough inquiry into these alleged irregularities, seeking action against those responsible for the financial misconduct. The complaint emphasizes the need for transparency and accountability in the ORR toll lease deal and related transactions.

## Telangana Police Now a Platform for Political Agendas: Praveen Kumar

**TPN Correspondent, Jagtial :** BRS leader Dr. R.S. Praveen Kumar criticized the Telangana Police during a media conference on law and order, accusing them of being influenced by political agendas. He highlighted that since the formation of the Congress government, the state has lacked a Home Minister, and there have been two changes in the Director General of Police (DGP). Despite recruitment of over 40,000 police personnel, Praveen Kumar claimed that law and order has significantly deteriorated in the past year.



Praveen Kumar pointed out that the police failed to take action even after Congress workers attacked police at a petrol pump in Jagtial, with a case only being

registered after the incident gained media attention. He also cited alarming increases in crime rates, with murders, rapes, and marijuana smuggling all on the rise, including an 82% increase in rapes involving women under 18. He alleged that the Telangana Police have become embroiled in political intrigues, failing to uphold the law and ensure safety for citizens. Praveen Kumar further criticized the current government for neglecting the police force's duty and for the decline in law and order across the state.

## Police Crack Down on Drug Gangs Ahead of New Year Celebrations

# A Murky Rivalry Brewing in India's Neighbourhood

The latest airstrikes by Pakistan on Afghan villages have sparked outrage in Kabul, with 46 people, including women and children, killed in an attack on Paktika province. This violent act comes after Pakistan's long history of backing insurgent groups like the Tehrik-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP), a by-product of its own policy of harboring militants. Ironically, the TTP is not an Afghan creation but the result of Pakistan's own strategic miscalculations. Former U.S. Secretary of State Hillary Clinton's 2011 warning about Pakistan keeping "snakes in its backyard" seems prophetic in this context, as these groups now target their former benefactor.

The strikes on Afghan territory, targeting alleged TTP leaders, came despite Pakistan's diplomatic efforts with Afghanistan. Pakistan's envoy, Mohammad Sadiq, had received a warm reception in Kabul, where Afghan officials expressed interest in maintaining good relations and enhancing trade. However, just hours after these diplomatic overtures, Pakistani fighter jets launched strikes in Barmal, Paktika, a region closely tied to Afghanistan's foreign minister, Amir Khan Muttaqi. This has escalated tensions, with Kabul summoning the Pakistani charge d'affaires to protest the strikes and assert Afghanistan's sovereignty.

Pakistan's military operations are partly driven by rising insecurity at home. This year, Pakistan has faced over 700 attacks, including brutal assaults on



its security forces. These strikes, coupled with unrest in tribal regions and conflicts in places like Kurram, have strained Pakistan's internal stability. The government's attempts to mediate in areas like Lakki Marwat and Kurram have only led to more resistance from local populations, particularly among Pashtuns, who have long felt marginalized. The arrest of leaders from the Pashtun Tahaffuz Movement (PTM) has intensified this sense of alienation, possibly pushing more people toward militant groups.

Kabul's response to Pakistan's actions could escalate into greater conflict. Afghanistan's Taliban, although divided, may retaliate against Pakistani targets, but this risks strengthening groups like the Islamic State Khorasan

(IS-K), which is already a significant threat to Kabul. The IS-K has been gaining ground, and its alliance with groups like the TTP poses a broader regional threat, including to neighboring countries like India.

India, in turn, needs to closely monitor developments in Afghanistan, especially as Pakistan continues to exert influence over Afghan factions. With the situation evolving rapidly, a larger incursion into the tribal areas and further instability along the Durand Line cannot be ruled out. This brewing rivalry between Afghanistan and Pakistan, fueled by a complex mix of territorial disputes, militant movements, and geopolitical ambitions, is likely to have far-reaching consequences in the region.



## China's Influence in Sri Lanka Faces Competition as New President Strengthens Ties with India

Sri Lankan President Anura Kumara Dissanayake's recent visit to New Delhi from December 15 to 17, 2024, marked a significant shift in Sri Lanka's foreign policy under his leadership. It was his first international trip since taking office in September, and the visit brought renewed optimism for stronger bilateral cooperation between India and Sri Lanka. The joint statement, titled "Fostering Partnerships for a Shared Future," highlighted the continuity of ties, despite initial concerns about Dissanayake's ideological stance and his party's historic opposition to Indian influence.

Dissanayake, widely known as AKD, had been portrayed as anti-India and pro-China due to his party's, the Janatha Vimukthi Peramuna (JVP), longstanding opposition to what it perceives as "Indian expansionism" in Sri Lanka. The JVP had also criticized the 13th Amendment to the Sri Lankan Constitution, a result of the 1987 India-Sri Lanka Accord, and had been resistant to agreements like the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA), which sought to further strengthen bilateral ties.

In addition to these historical concerns, AKD's campaign rhetoric included plans to halt the 484 MW wind power projects in northeastern Sri Lanka—projects being developed by India's Adani Green Energy. This \$440 million venture, which was set to span over 20 years, had already sparked tensions, as critics argued it symbolized growing Indian economic influence in Sri Lanka's strategic regions.

However, the outcome of Dissanayake's visit to India helped dispel many of the concerns surrounding his government's foreign policy. During the trip, he thanked Prime Minister Narendra Modi for India's swift and substantial financial assistance following Sri Lanka's 2022 sovereign default. India's support, amounting to \$4 billion, was pivotal in stabilizing Sri Lanka's economy during its financial crisis. The president's reaffirmation of Sri Lanka's commitment to deepen ties with India in multiple sectors, including security, trade, and investment, indicated a shift away from the narrative of increased Chinese influence in the region.

This visit also signaled a renewed focus on regional security and prosperity, underscoring Sri Lanka's strategic position in the Indian Ocean. While China has been a key player in Sri Lanka's infrastructure development, especially through loans and projects under its Belt and Road Initiative, Dissanayake's engagement with India suggests that Sri Lanka is balancing its relationships with both global powers, with India emerging as a key partner in Sri Lanka's economic recovery and long-term development. As Sri Lanka navigates its post-crisis recovery, it appears that India will continue to play a pivotal role, making it unlikely that China will gain greater leverage in the island nation under the new administration.

## Reevaluating India's Election Process: Beyond the EVM Debate

India, the debate surrounding the manipulation of elections, their results, and particularly Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs), has been an ongoing issue for years. The introduction of over a million EVMs in all 543 constituencies of the Lok Sabha during the 2004 general elections sparked a wave of discussions, and the issue remains contentious, especially since the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) first raised concerns about their integrity in 2010.

EVMs were originally presented as stand-alone machines. However, they are, in fact, part of a larger system, comprising two machines: the Electronic Voting Machine (EVM) and a Control Unit, alongside Symbol Loading Units (SLUs) when necessary. The Election Commission of India (ECI) later began referring to the EVMs as Balloting Units, but the underlying system — consisting of four machines in total — is what forms the

Electronic Voting System (EVS) or Polling System.

While the EVMs undoubtedly play a crucial role in the election process, it's important to acknowledge that they represent just one part of the broader framework that facilitates elections. As poet Faiz Ahmad Faiz famously said, "Aur bhi dukh hain zamaane mein mohabbat ke siva" — meaning that there are many other concerns that come into play in the election process beyond just the machines.

The focus on EVMs has dominated the political discourse, especially in light of controversies surrounding their reliability. However, as recent elections — including the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, Haryana and Maharashtra assembly polls, and various by-elections — have shown, much can happen before the EVS even takes over the voting process. Manipulations, irregularities, and other factors can occur long

before ballots are cast and counted.


In understanding the complete electoral process, it's essential to recognize the multiple components that comprise what should be called the National Electoral System (NES). The NES can be broken down into four major components: Voter Roll, Scheduling, the Electronic Voting System (EVS), and Post-Poll Activities. Each of these elements plays a significant role in ensuring the legitimacy and transparency of elections, and they deserve more attention than the singular focus on EVMs.

The National Electoral System needs to be considered holistically, and efforts should be made to improve transparency and trust across all its components, not just the EVMs. The integrity of the entire process — from voter registration to the final result — is crucial for maintaining faith in the democratic process.

# India's Next Big Export: UPI Set To Lead Global Digital Payments Revolution

India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI) has become a transformative force in the world of digital transactions, revolutionising how people in the country manage and conduct payments. The initiative, spearheaded by Prime Minister Narendra Modi's push for a cashless economy, has reshaped India's financial landscape by combining efforts focused on digital infrastructure, financial inclusion, and internet connectivity. This has drastically changed the way Indians make transactions, contributing significantly to the country's financial growth and expanding the user base across all segments.

Moreover, UPI is expanding its reach to nations such as Oman, Saudi Arabia, Australia, and the United Kingdom. India's National Payments Corporation (NPCI) has established the NIPL (NPCI International Payments Ltd) to lead UPI's international expansion, collaborating with countries like Trinidad and Tobago, Peru, Namibia, and Rwanda to help them develop their own digital payment systems inspired by the UPI framework.

The global reception to UPI is particu-

larly significant for nations in the Global South, where UPI's potential to drive financial inclusion at a mass scale is seen as revolutionary. UPI has already surpassed global digital payment giants such as PayPal, Alipay, and Brazil's PIX in terms of transaction volume. Between April and July 2024, UPI processed nearly Rs 81 lakh crore worth of transactions, cementing its position as a leader in the global digital payments space.

India's UPI is not only transforming its own financial ecosystem but also revolutionising the global payments landscape, particularly in developing countries. With increasing international partnerships and an expanding global presence, UPI is poised to become one of India's most significant exports, setting the stage for a new era of seamless, inclusive, and innovative digital transactions worldwide.

## Not very lucky on security front, must stay vigilant: Rajnath Warns of Security Challenges

The Mhow Cantonment, which is located 25 kilometers from Indore, is home to several prestigious military institutions, including the Army War College, Military College of Telecommunication Engineering, and Infantry School. It also houses the Infantry Museum and the Army Marksmanship Unit. Singh emphasized the importance of these institutions in preparing soldiers for the challenges they face.

"We also face challenges on the internal front. In the backdrop of this, we can't sit quiet, unconcerned. Our enemies, whether internal or external, always remain active. In these circumstances, we must keep an eye on their activities and take appropriate and timely steps against them," he added.

Singh further highlighted the crucial role of the Indian Army in securing the nation and supporting its journey towards becoming a self-reliant and developed country.

## Bihar Govt Has Become Symbol Of Atrocity On Youths: Priyanka Gandhi

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra criticized the "double-engine" BJP government in Bihar, calling it a symbol of "atrocities on youth" after police used water cannons to disperse students protesting against the cancellation of the Bihar Public Service Commission (BPSC) exam. The incident occurred on Sunday when students gathered at Gandhi Maidan, demanding the cancellation of the BPSC exam held on December 13 due to allegations of corruption and paper leaks.

In a post on X (formerly Twitter), Priyanka Gandhi stated, "It is the government's job to stop corruption, rigging, and paper leaks in examinations. But instead of addressing these issues, students are being prevented from raising their voices." Her remarks came a day after the protest turned tense, with students attempting to march towards the residence of Bihar's Chief Minister. The police intervened, using water cannons to disperse the crowd, a move that sparked further outrage. The students were joined by Prashant Kishore, the founder of Jan Suraj, who lent his support to the protesters. Authorities confirmed that the police had to take action as the students tried to march toward the Chief Minister's residence. The protests were a reaction to what students believe is an unfair examination process, exacerbated by corruption and administrative lapses.

The situation has ignited a political controversy, with opposition leaders accusing the state government of failing to address the concerns of the youth. The incident has also drawn attention to the growing frustration among students in Bihar, who feel their voices are being silenced in the face of systemic corruption and inefficiencies.



## TVK Chief Vijay Meets Tamil Nadu Governor Over Sex Assault At Anna University

Actor-turned-politician Vijay met Tamil Nadu Governor RN Ravi in Chennai amid widespread outrage over the sexual assault of a second-year student at Anna University on December 23. The incident has sparked protests across Tamil Nadu, leading to the arrest of one person and the formation of four special police teams to investigate the case.

The Students' Federation of India (SFI) and the All India Women Welfare Federation held demonstrations outside Anna University's Guindy campus, demanding justice and stronger security measures for women in educational institutions. In response to the incident, Vijay, leader of Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam (TVK), expressed his shock and concern, calling it "deeply shocking and painful." He urged the Tamil Nadu government to take swift legal action against the accused and ensure justice.

Vijay also proposed the use of the Nirbhaya Fund to install smart poles equipped with emergency buttons, CCTV cameras, and telephones in vulnerable areas. He called for the creation of mobile apps and emergency hotlines for women's safety and emphasized the need for better restroom facilities in public spaces.

Meanwhile, the Madras High Court intervened by constituting an all-women Special Investigation Team (SIT), led by IPS officers Sneha Priya, Ayman Jamal, and Brinda. The SIT has been tasked with investigating not only the sexual assault but also the leak of the victim's FIR. The court has ordered the Tamil Nadu government to provide Rs 25 lakh as compensation to the victim and ensure she receives free education, along with boarding, lodging, and counseling support.

The ruling DMK government faces increasing political pressure, with BJP Tamil Nadu president K Annamalai protesting by whipping himself outside his home, accusing the DMK of failing to ensure women's safety. The National Commission for Women (NCW) has also dispatched a two-member team to investigate the case and monitor the response from authorities.

## Kejriwal Announces Monthly Allowance for Priests and Granthis Ahead of Delhi Elections

In a bid to retain power for a fourth consecutive term, Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) chief Arvind Kejriwal announced a new welfare scheme for Hindu temple priests and granthis of gurdwaras on Monday. Titled the Pujari Granthi Samman Yojana, the scheme promises a monthly allowance of Rs 18,000 to these religious leaders, aimed at recognizing their contribution to society.

Speaking about the initiative, Kejriwal emphasized that priests and granthis often remain neglected despite their vital role in communities. "For the first time in the country, we are introducing a scheme to support them, under which they will receive a monthly honorarium of Rs 18,000," Kejriwal said. He further stated that the scheme would help provide financial security to these religious workers, many of whom operate on minimal income.

The announcement, which comes ahead of the Delhi Assembly elections, is part of the AAP's strategy to connect with a broader section of voters. Kejriwal made it clear that the scheme would only be implemented if the AAP is re-elected to govern the city-state. Registration for the scheme is set to begin on Tuesday, with Kejriwal planning to visit the Hanuman temple in Connaught Place to oversee the registration process for priests.

The decision to introduce such a welfare scheme highlights AAP's focus on addressing the concerns of religious communities in the capital, as it seeks to consolidate its position ahead of the elections. Kejriwal's announcement has generated significant attention, with both supporters and critics weighing in on the potential impact of the scheme. As the election date approaches, this move could play a crucial role in shaping voter sentiment in Delhi.

## Don't Fall For BJP's Money: Mamata Banerjee's Message To Sandeshkhali

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee, during her first visit to Sandeshkhali since the sex harassment controversy erupted, took a strong dig at the BJP, urging people not to be swayed by lies or money. Banerjee, who was in the riverine island to oversee a public distribution programme, accused the BJP of spreading false narratives and indulging in political manipulation.



Banerjee urged the locals to be cautious and not attend meetings or events orchestrated by the BJP. "Even if someone calls you, don't go. It's your right not to go," she said. The Chief Minister further warned of the dangers posed by the Left, accusing them of political violence in the past. "If something happens in Sandeshkhali, I will hear about it in minutes. I work as a 'paharadar' (watchman) for the people. If you are fine, I will be fine," she added.

"Here, a lot of money has been involved, and later everything turned out to be lies," said Banerjee, addressing the crowd. "Don't fall for the prey of naughty men... Don't fall for BJP's money... Bring down defamation, lies, and misinformation, and let peace prevail here." Her remarks were a direct reference to the controversy that the BJP had stoked ahead of the Lok Sabha election.

The controversy began with allegations of sex harassment and land grabbing against Trinamool Congress (TMC) leader Sheikh Shahjahan. The TMC claimed the allegations were politically motivated, especially after a video surfaced in which a former BJP leader allegedly confessed that the incident had been "scripted by the BJP." While the BJP used the issue to accuse the TMC of misrule and exploitation of women, the TMC managed to retain the Basirhat seat, which includes the Sandeshkhali assembly area.

Amid the uproar, the TMC suspended Sheikh Shahjahan along with his two associates, Shibu Prasad Hazra and Utam Sardar. Shahjahan was later arrested after evading police for two months, following an incident in which his supporters attacked Enforcement Directorate officials visiting Sandeshkhali in January.



## Sri Lanka's Human Rights Commission Denied Access to Rohingya Refugees in Military Camp

COLOMBO: Sri Lanka's Human Rights Commission (HRCSL) has expressed concern over being denied permission to visit Rohingya refugees who are being held at a military camp in Mullaitivu, northern Sri Lanka. The HRCSL wrote a formal letter to President Anura Kumara Dissanayake on December 26, alleging that its team, including senior officials, was blocked from assessing the conditions of the refugees detained at the Sri Lanka Air Force Camp.

The Rohingya refugees, over 100 in total, were rescued by the Sri Lanka Navy on December 20 after being found in a distressed condition off the northeastern coast of the island. The group was spotted by local fishermen near the Velamullivaikkal area in Mullaitivu. The Sri Lankan government suspects that the refugees were part of a human trafficking operation, with Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs Arun Hemachandra labeling them as illegal immigrants.

Despite the growing humanitarian concerns, the HRCSL's attempt to inspect the



living conditions of these refugees was thwarted. The Commission had aimed to ensure that the refugees were being treated humanely and to assess whether their detention met international human rights standards.

The situation has sparked widespread debate about Sri Lanka's treatment of refugees and its broader refugee policy.

Human rights organizations have called for transparency and accountability, urging the government to reconsider its handling of such cases and to uphold its commitments to international human rights law. The case continues to highlight the challenges faced by refugees fleeing persecution, as well as the tension between security concerns and humanitarian obligations.

## Crashed Plane was Shot At From Russia: Azerbaijan President



BAKU: Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev has claimed that a passenger plane, which crashed last week and killed 38 people, was damaged by an accidental shooting from the ground in Russia. Aliyev, speaking on Sunday, suggested that some officials in Russia had misrepresented the cause of the disaster.

The crash involved Azerbaijan Airlines

Flight J2-8243, which tragically went down after encountering trouble in Russian airspace. The incident occurred as Russia's air defenses were engaged in combat with Ukrainian attack drones. Russian President Vladimir Putin expressed regret for the "tragic incident" in a statement on Saturday, but the Kremlin did not confirm any direct responsibility for downing the plane. Instead, the statement mentioned

that a criminal investigation had been initiated into the incident.

Aliyev, however, clarified that the plane had been shot at unintentionally while approaching Grozny, a city in southern Russia. The Azerbaijani president added that the aircraft was also subject to some form of electronic jamming, which may have contributed to the confusion leading to the shooting. Despite the severity of the incident, the pilots were praised for their heroic efforts in executing a controlled landing, which allowed 29 of the passengers to survive.

The tragic crash has raised serious questions about the safety of civilian air traffic in regions affected by military operations. It has also added to the tense relationship between Azerbaijan and Russia, as both countries now look to address the cause of the crash and its broader implications for aviation security.

The investigation into the crash is still ongoing, with both Russian and Azerbaijani authorities looking into the details of the shooting and its accidental nature. The incident has become a point of contention, with both governments seeking clarity and accountability in the wake of the disaster.



## Jimmy Carter, Former U.S. President and Nobel Peace Prize Laureate, Dies at 100

WASHINGTON: Jimmy Carter, the earnest Georgia peanut farmer who served as the 39th president of the United States, passed away on Sunday at the age of 100, according to the Carter Center. He died peacefully at his home in Plains, Georgia. Carter's legacy as a statesman and humanitarian is cemented by his achievements during and after his presidency.

"My father was a hero, not only to me but to everyone who believes in peace, human rights, and unselfish love," said his son Chip Carter. "The world is our family because of the way he brought people together, and we thank you for honoring his memory by continuing to live these shared beliefs."

Carter, a Democrat, served as president from 1977 to 1981, defeating incumbent Republican President Gerald Ford in the 1976 election. Despite facing challenges during his presidency, such as a struggling economy and the Iran hostage crisis, Carter brokered a historic peace agreement between Israel and Egypt at the 1978 Camp David Accords, an accomplishment that earned him the Nobel Peace Prize in 2002 for his humanitarian efforts.

Though Carter's presidency ended in defeat to Republican Ronald Reagan in 1980, his post-presidency years garnered widespread admiration. He lived longer after his time in office than any other U.S. president and became known as a better former president than during his time in office—a status Carter himself acknowledged.

His presidency was marked by efforts to promote human rights and bring stability to the Middle East, but it was also marred by domestic economic struggles and the international humiliation of the Iran hostage crisis, which lasted for 444 days. Despite these challenges, Carter's legacy as a peacemaker and humanitarian continues to shape his place in history.

## Syrian Elections Could Take 4 Years: Rebel Leader Ahmed Al-Sharaa



DUBAI: In a recent interview with Al Arabiya TV, Syria's new leader Ahmed al-Sharaa discussed his plans for the country's political future, the role of foreign relations, and the impact of sanctions. Following the ousting of Bashar al-Assad by his Islamist group, Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS), and allied rebels, Sharaa indicated that Syria's election process could take up to four years, emphasizing the need to rewrite the constitution, which could take an additional two or three years. He reaffirmed the importance of drafting a new constitution and holding UN-supervised elections, as outlined in United Nations Security Council Resolution 2254, adopted in 2015. Sharaa also expressed hope that under the administration of US President-elect Donald Trump, sanctions imposed on Syria under Assad's regime would be lifted. He argued that since Assad is no longer in power, these sanctions should be automatically removed.

On the subject of Syria's foreign relations, Sharaa underscored the importance of maintaining strong ties with Russia and Iran. Both countries have been crucial allies of Assad, aiding him in reclaiming territory throughout Syria's ongoing war. Sharaa stated that Syria cannot function without its relationship with Iran, noting that it must be based on mutual respect for sovereignty and non-interference. He also acknowledged Russia's significant influence in Syria, calling it "the second most powerful country in the world," with deep strategic interests, particularly in military presence and infrastructure.

Sharaa also discussed the integration of Kurdish-led forces, which Turkey opposes, into Syria's national army. He emphasized that all arms should be controlled by the state, and that the Syrian Democratic Forces (SDF), which played a crucial role in defeating ISIS, should be welcomed into the defense ministry.

## EAM Jaishankar To Embark On 3-Day Doha Visit Today, To Meet Qatari PM

NEW DELHI: External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar will begin a three-day official visit to Qatar on December 30 to review and enhance bilateral relations between the two nations. His visit will focus on key sectors including trade, investment, energy, and security, the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) announced. The visit is set to conclude on January 1.

During his stay, Jaishankar is expected to meet with Qatari leaders, including Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman bin Jassim Al Thani. The discussions will cover various aspects of the India-Qatar partnership, ranging from political and economic cooperation to cultural exchanges and people-to-people ties. Both sides will also address regional and global issues of mutual concern.

This visit follows a series of high-level engagements between the two nations. The Nifty, which started with gains in the morning, crashed shortly after. It closed at 23,644 with a total loss of 168 points. The Sensex, however, recovered slightly from the loss of 850 points and closed with a loss of 459 points. The indices are likely to rise only if there are positive signals from the international markets.



The BSE Sensex, which closed at 78,699 in the previous session, started at 78,637 today. It touched an intraday low of 78,077. It reached an intraday high of 79,092. Finally, it closed at 78,248 with a loss of 450 points. The NSE Nifty, which opened at 23,796 on Monday, touched a low of 23,599 and a high of 23,915. It closed at 23,644, down 168 points. The Bank Nifty, meanwhile, fell 358 points to settle at 50,952.

In the Nifty50, 11 companies gained while 38 lost. Adani Enterprises, Tech Mahindra, HCL Tech, IndusInd Bank, Shriram Finance were the top gainers. Hindalco, Tata Motors, Trent, BEL, Wipro lost the most. FMCG, IT, Pharma, Healthcare, and Consumer Durables indices rose today. Bank, auto, finance, media, metal, realty, oil and gas indices rose.

Market breadth on NSE today was in favour of sellers. Of the 2942 shares traded, 947 gained and 1913 lost. Shares of 69 companies hit 52-week highs while 97 hit 52-week lows. Rupee settled flat at 85.54 against the dollar. KEC International received orders worth Rs 1073 crore from various companies. Nifty Pharma index surged. Shares of Biocon, Lupin and JB Chemicals rose by 3-4%. Adani Enterprises rose by 7% as brokerages gave buy calls with a target price of Rs 3801. Rocking deals to invest Rs 100 crore for growth. ## Google Tests New Animation for AI Search Summaries

Google may be testing a fresh animation for its AI search summary feature, known as AI Overviews. The new animation, which replaces the previous blue lines shown while preparing a summary for a search query, introduces a more dynamic visual effect. Instead of the standard blue lines, users now see a roaming spotlight effect in blue and purple, which closely resembles the animation seen in Google’s Gemini AI assistant on Android and Gemini Live.

The discovery was first shared on December 28, 2024, by Reddit user Gaiden206, who posted a screenshot on the Bard subreddit, showcasing the new loading animation. The post quickly garnered attention, with several other users in the comments reporting that they, too, had noticed the updated animation. According to a report from 9to5Google, the animation is currently visible to a select group of users, but it has not been rolled out to everyone globally yet.

While the change is still being tested, the new animation adds an extra layer of interactivity and style to the AI search experience, making the wait for a query’s AI-generated summary feel less static. However, not all users are seeing the animation at this time, as it seems to be limited to a test phase. Gadgets 360 staff also noted that they could not verify the presence of the



new animation, suggesting that it is still in the early stages of testing.

The ongoing testing of new features like this highlights Google’s continued efforts to refine and enhance the AI search experience, offering users a more visually engaging and interactive way to receive information. As this animation continues to be tested, it remains to be seen whether it will be adopted widely for all users in the future.

## Why Disinfectants Can Never Promise 100% Germ Elimination

Have you ever wondered why disinfectants often claim to kill 99.9% or 99.99% of germs but never promise to eradicate all of them? In a world where science has made incredible advancements, it might seem surprising that a disinfectant can’t be 100% effective. The answer lies in a combination of microbiology and mathematics.

Disinfectants are substances used to kill or inactivate harmful microbes such as bacteria, viruses, and fungi on surfaces. While most microbes are harmless—and some even beneficial—a small number can cause illness.

Disinfection typically involves chemical agents, although physical methods like heat and UV light can also be used. However, it’s the mathematical pattern behind microbial elimination that explains why a disinfectant can never guarantee total



eradication. Microbial populations grow exponentially, meaning that a colony of 100 bacteria can double every hour, leading to a rapid increase in their numbers.

On the flip side, the process of killing or inactivating microbes follows a logarithmic decay pattern, which is the reverse of exponential growth. As disinfectants work, the number of surviving microbes

decreases, but the rate of death slows over time. For example, if a disinfectant kills 90% of bacteria every minute, after the first minute only 10% of the original population remains. After another minute, only 1% of the original population would remain, and so on.

This pattern of logarithmic decay is why it’s impossible to guarantee the death of every microbe. With each minute, fewer microbes remain, making it increasingly difficult to eliminate the last few. Therefore, disinfectants can only reduce microbial populations

by a fixed percentage, not entirely eliminate them.

In conclusion, while disinfectants are highly effective at reducing germs, the nature of microbial growth and decay means it’s not possible to ever claim 100% eradication. The 99.9% and 99.99% figures are a reflection of the science behind the process, not a failure of the products.



## Jasprit Bumrah Nominated for ICC Test Cricketer of the Year Award

India's star fast bowler, Jasprit Bumrah, has been nominated for the prestigious ICC Test Cricketer of the Year award. He is competing alongside England's Joe Root and Harry Brook, and Sri Lanka's Kamindu Mendis. Bumrah, who has been in sensational form in 2024, has taken 71 wickets from 13 matches at an average of 14.92 and a strike rate of 30.16, making him the top-performing bowler in Test cricket this year.

The ICC highlighted Bumrah's remarkable return to the Test arena after recovering from a recurring back injury in 2023. His exceptional performances in 2024 saw him finish the year with more wickets than any other bowler. Notably, his match-winning spells during India's tour of Australia, including his memorable efforts in Perth, were among his standout performances. His 30 wickets in just four matches during the Border-Gavaskar Trophy have cemented his place as the premier fast bowler of the year.

In addition to Bumrah, England's Joe Root is also nominated, having scored 1,556 runs in 17 Tests at an average



of 55.57. Root's stellar year included six centuries and five fifties, with a career-best 262 against Pakistan. His consistency with the bat made him one of the most dominant players of the year.

Harry Brook, another English cricketer, earned a spot in the shortlist with 1,100 runs from 12 Tests at an average of 55.00. Known for his aggressive batting, Brook scored four centuries, including a blistering 317, with the majority of his runs coming in overseas conditions.

Sri Lanka's Kamindu Mendis also had a standout year, scoring 1,049 runs from nine Tests at an impressive average of 74.92. Mendis became the joint-third quickest to reach 1,000 Test runs, equalling Sir Don Bradman's record with 13 innings. His twin centuries against New Zealand were among his most memorable performances.

These exceptional players will now vie for the ICC Test Cricketer of the Year honor, showcasing their outstanding contributions to the longest format of the game.

## Australia Clinch 184-Run Victory Over India in MCG Test, Lead Series 2-1

Australia stunned India by taking seven wickets in the final session of the fourth Test in Melbourne on Monday to win by 184 runs, taking a 2-1 lead in the five-match series. India, set an improbable 340 runs to win, collapsed to 155 all out with just 12.5 overs left in the match. With this loss, India now faces a must-win scenario in the final Test, starting on Friday in Sydney, if they hope to level the series and retain the Border-Gavaskar Trophy.

Australia's captain, Pat Cummins, was the standout performer, taking 3-28, including the crucial wicket of Yashasvi Jaiswal, who was India's top scorer with 84. Jaiswal's departure sparked a dramatic collapse as India's last seven wickets fell for just 34 runs in 20.3 overs. Despite India's solid middle-order partnership between Jaiswal and Rishabh Pant, who survived the second session to take the score to 112-3 at tea, the game turned when Pant was dismissed for 30. Pant was caught in the deep after an ill-advised shot off part-time spinner Travis Head.

The wickets of Ravindra Jadeja and Nitish Kumar Reddy followed shortly after, and Jaiswal was dismissed in controver-



sial fashion. The TV umpire overturned an initial not-out decision after reviewing a caught-behind appeal from an attempted hook, despite no sound being picked up by technology, as visual evidence suggested the ball had changed direction.

Scott Boland (3-39) removed Akash Deep, while Jasprit Bumrah registered his second duck of the match. Mohammed Siraj was the final wicket to fall, trapped lbw by Nathan Lyon (2-37).

Earlier, India's top order had struggled in the first session, with Rohit Sharma, KL Rahul, and Virat Kohli all falling for single-digit scores. Cummins rounded off an excellent Test match, finishing with six wickets and scoring 90 runs—his best batting performance in a Test series.

## Liverpool Thrash West Ham 5-0, Extend Premier League Lead to Eight Points



Liverpool extended their lead at the top of the Premier League with a dominant 5-0 victory over West Ham, opening up an eight-point gap in the race for the title. Goals from Luis Diaz, Cody Gakpo, Mohamed Salah, Trent Alexander-Arnold, and Diogo Jota sealed the commanding win at the London Stadium, as Liverpool ended 2024 as the favorites to secure their second league title in 35 years.

Despite the emphatic victory, Liverpool's manager, Arne Slot, reminded everyone that there's still a long way to go, with the team just one game short of the halfway point in the season. Slot, who took over from Jurgen Klopp, has now guided Liverpool to 23 wins in 27 matches across all competitions, and his managerial debut has been nothing short of impressive.

The Reds were relentless from the start, with Diaz breaking the deadlock in the 30th minute. His intended pass to Curtis Jones rebounded off a West Ham defender and fell kindly for the Colombian, who slot-

ted the ball into the corner. West Ham's Mohammed Kudus almost equalized but saw his effort strike the post.

Just before halftime, Liverpool put the game to bed with two quick-fire goals. Gakpo netted his ninth goal in 14 games, thanks to a brilliant turn and assist from Salah, before Salah himself curled a shot past Alphonse Areola to make it 3-0, reaching the 20-goal mark for the eighth consecutive season.

Alexander-Arnold added to the misery for West Ham with a thunderous strike that deflected in off Max Kilman, and Jota sealed the win with a fifth goal after a superb assist from Salah, who registered his 13th Premier League assist of the season.

Liverpool's dominance this season continues to shine, with speculation over the futures of Alexander-Arnold, Salah, and Virgil van Dijk failing to derail their title charge. Salah, focused on the team's success, emphasized that winning the league remains the top priority.

## Manchester Secures First Win in Five League Matches with 2-0 Victory Over Leicester

Manchester City secured a crucial 2-0 victory over Leicester City at King Power Stadium on Sunday, marking their first win in five Premier League matches. The victory, achieved in Pep Guardiola's 500th game in charge, was vital for the defending champions as they look to close the gap at the top of the Premier League.

The win was City's second in 14 games across all competitions, lifting them to fifth place in the standings with 31 points, 11 points behind leaders Liverpool, who have two games in hand. Leicester, on the other hand, remained in the relegation zone in 18th place, continuing their struggle in the league.
