Tensions Rise in Hyderabad as Senior BRS Leaders Arrested

Political Tensions Escalate Following Arrests of BRS Leaders BRS Leaders Condemn Congress Government's Handling of Dissent Police Detain Senior BRS Leaders, Sparking Statewide Protests Rama Rao Criticizes Congress for Undemocratic Actions Against Opposition

TPN, Hyderabad: Tensions escalated in Hyderabad on Thursday as Cyberabad police arrested senior BRS leaders, including MLAs T Harish Rao, G Jagadish Reddy, and Padi Kaushik Reddy, amid high drama. The arrests intensified the political clash between the ruling BRS and law enforcement, sparking widespread protests by party supporters across the state.



The drama began in the early morning when police arrived at Kaushik Reddy's residence in Kondapur to arrest him in connection with a case filed the previous day at Banjara Hills police station. The case stemmed from a confrontation when Kaushik Reddy visited the station to lodge a complaint about alleged phone tapping by the Congress government. Tensions flared when Kaushik Reddy insisted that the Station House Officer, KM Raghavendra, stay to receive his

complaint. The police accused Reddy of obstructing a public servant and filed charges including unlawful assembly, rioting, and criminal intimidation.

BRS leaders, including working president KT Rama Rao and senior MLA T Harish Rao, condemned the actions of the Congress government and questioned the state of governance in Telangana. They accused the police of suppressing opposition by arresting BRS leaders instead of

addressing the serious allegations raised by Kaushik Reddy. As the situation intensified, Harish Rao, Jagadish Reddy, and other BRS leaders arrived at Kaushik Reddy's residence, only to be detained by the police. The detained leaders were shifted to Gachibowli and Raidurg police stations. Despite efforts by the BRS to secure their release, the leaders remained in custody for over seven hours.

TPN, Telangana: Tensions ran high at Gachibowli police station in Hyderabad as senior BRS leaders, including MLA Harish Rao, were arrested along with other party members. The arrests followed the detainment of Kaushik Reddy by Banjara Hills police. In response, BRS MLAs Palla Rajeshwar Reddy and Sudheer Reddy joined other party leaders to secure Harish Rao's release.

After being freed, Harish Rao addressed the media, condemning the state's governance. He claimed that Telangana is not

being ruled by the people, but by a "demon," referring to Chief Minister Revanth Reddy. Harish Rao accused Revanth Reddy of taking revenge on BRS leaders and continuing a reign of hostility. He also criticized the handling of issues like women's safety in Lagacharla and questioned the unfulfilled promises made to farmers. Rao alleged that police stations across the state have become "Congress offices," urging law enforcement to operate within legal boundaries. He further emphasized that political positions are not permanent and should be used responsibly.

PSLV-C59 Rocket **Successfully Launche**

PSLV-C59 Launches Solar Study Mission Proba-3 Satellites to Explore Sun's Corona ISRO's Successful Proba-3 Launch

TPN, Telangana: The PSLV-C59 rocket successfully launched into space from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, carrying the Proba-3 satellites into orbit. This mission, led by the European Space Agency (ESA), aims to unveil the secrets of the Sun's outer atmosphere, or corona, by creating an artificial solar eclipse.

Initially scheduled for yesterday, the launch was postponed due to a last-minute technical issue with the Proba-3 spacecraft, but it successfully lifted off today. The mission was launched by IS-RO's commercial arm, New Space India Limited (NSIL).

The Proba-3 mission consists of two satellites, the Coronagraph Spacecraft and the Occult Spacecraft, each weighing around 550 kg. These satellites will orbit Earth in a highly elliptical orbit and work together to simulate solar eclipse conditions. One satellite will create the artificial eclipse, while the other will closely observe the Sun's corona. The success of the mission depends on the precise coordination of these two satellites, as one malfunction could render the entire mission ineffective.


The Proba-3 mission is a collaborative effort involving scientists from Spain, Poland, Belgium, Italy, and Switzerland, marking a significant step in solar research.



(BRS) leader RS Praveen Kumar made sensational allegations against Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, accusing him of misusing power to target opposition leaders and suppress dissent. Telangana Regime to Indiramma's Emergency-Kavitha

Kavitha Condemns Arrests of BRS Leaders Allegations of Police Misuse in Telangana Call for Withdrawal of Cases Against BRS Leaders



TPN, **Hyderabad:** BRS MLC Kalvakuntla Kavitha strongly criticized the current administration in Telangana, likening it to the Emergency era under Indira Gandhi. Her remarks came after the arrest of BRS leaders Harish Rao and Padi Kaushik Reddy, who were taken to Gachibowli police station.

Kavitha visited the police station to meet the detained leaders and later addressed the media. She condemned the government for its alleged oppressive actions, warning that public discontent would eventually lead to a revolt.

Detailing the incident, Kavitha stated that Padi Kaushik Reddy had approached the Banjara Hills police station to file a complaint after securing an appointment with the ACP. However, when the ACP was unavailable, Reddy questioned the CI, leading to a case being filed against him.

Kavitha criticized the arrests of Harish Rao and Jagadish Reddy, claiming they were unjustly detained for visiting Kaushik Reddy's residence. She accused the government of lacking the courage to accept complaints and demanded the withdrawal of "illegal cases" against BRS leaders.

She called for the immediate release of those arrested, reiterating her stance against the alleged misuse of police power.

Ponguleti Sudhakar Reddy Criticizes Congress and BRS

TPN, **Hyderabad**: BJP Tamil Nadu in-charge Ponguleti Sudhakar Reddy launched a sharp attack on the Congress and BRS parties, criticizing their governance and accusing them of deceiving the public. Addressing Congress's six guarantees and pre-election promises, Sudhakar claimed that the party failed to deliver on its commitments despite promising to fulfill them within the first 100 days of coming to power.



Sudhakar ridiculed Congress's celebrations of their rule, likening it to "hanging a chicken in a movie and eating rice." He further alleged that Congress waived off loans selectively and failed to honor its promise of waiving Rs 2 lakh loans for all eligible individuals.

gress of borrowing Rs 50,000 crore in addition to the Rs 7 lakh crore debt incurred by the BRS under KCR's leadership. He likened KCR's governance to a "degree in corrupt administration" while suggesting that Revanth Reddy has a "Ph.D. in corruption."

Sudhakar accused Congress of shielding BRS's failures and announced that the BJP would release a chargesheet exposing their misleading actions. He praised Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership, asserting that India is on its way to becoming a global powerhouse.

Legal Action Warning by Surekha

Surekha Criticizes Disruptive Assembly Behavior Allegations Against KTR on Misinformation Congress Defends Ministers Amid Opposition Attacks

TPN, **Hyderabad**: Telangana Forest Minister Konda Surekha has issued a strong warning to opposition leaders, particularly members of the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS), over their criticisms of Congress ministers. She cautioned that legal action would be initiated against those making defamatory remarks, further intensifying the political rivalry in the state.

Surekha singled out BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy, accusing him of disrupting Assembly proceedings with unruly behavior. "He has lost his mind. The Huzurabad MLA keeps disrupting the house by clapping and shouting," she said.

The minister also criticized BJP MLA Paidi Rakesh Reddy, alleging that he verbally abused Roads and Buildings Minister Komatired-dy Venkat Reddy. She defended the Congress government's directives instructing district Collectors to include Congress leaders in official events, emphasizing the importance of party unity and public engagement.

Surekha launched a scathing attack on BRS working president K.T. Rama Rao (KTR), accusing him of using "objectionable language" against Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy and spreading misinformation about state finances. She also alleged that KTR is misusing social media to influence Telangana's youth against the Congress-led government.

This isn't the first time Surekha has courted controversy. Previously, she faced backlash for linking KTR to the divorce of Tolly-



wood actors Samantha Ruth Prabhu and Naga Chaitanya—a statement she later retracted under pressure from the film industry. Despite this, her criticisms of KTR have remained sharp, further escalating tensions between Congress and BRS.

Surekha's latest remarks underscore the growing conflict between the ruling Congress and opposition parties, setting the stage for a heated political battle in Telangana.

Balmoor Venkat Slams Kaushik Reddy, Issues Warning

TPN, Hyderabad: MLC Balmoor Venkat launched a scathing attack on BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy, accusing him of erratic behavior and creating unnecessary drama. Venkat likened Reddy to a "mad dog," alleging that his actions at the police station were staged to gain attention on social media.

"Kaushik Reddy behaves arrogantly after being called an MLA. He betrayed his own party and now tries to portray himself as a star by causing unnecessary disruptions," Venkat remarked, criticizing Reddy's theatrics at the police station.

Venkat also targeted BRS leadership, questioning Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) and MLC K. Kavitha over allegations of corruption and misconduct. "Ask KCR about the brokers, thieves, and those hiding in farmhouses. Ask Kavitha about the Sara Buddi case, and you'll know who the real culprits are," he said.

The MLC warned both Kaushik Reddy and Minister Harish Rao of legal consequences if they continued to act irresponsibly. "If you make mistakes, there will be cases and legal procedures. This is a warning to Kaushik Reddy and Harish Rao," he stated.

Venkat's fiery remarks highlight the ongoing tensions between Congress and BRS in Telangana's political landscape.



Errabelli Dayakar Rao Stages Protest Over Arrest of BRS Leaders



TPN, **Hyderabad**: Former Minister Errabelli Dayakar Rao staged a sit-in protest in front of the Banjara Hills Police Station, condemning the arrest of BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy and other leaders. Dayakar Rao criticized the police for allegedly detaining Reddy without providing any information or justification.

"The police have illegally arrested Kaushik Reddy and are wasting time under the guise of investigation instead of presenting him in court. Even meeting him at the station was denied," he alleged. Dayakar Rao demanded that Reddy be produced in court immediately and accused the police of procedural violations.

The controversy began when Kaushik Reddy visited the Banjara Hills police station on Wednesday to file a complaint about phone tapping. Despite prior notice, the ACP was unavailable, and the CI attempted to avoid taking the complaint. Following a confrontation, CI Raghavendra lodged a complaint, leading to cases being filed against Reddy and 20 of his followers under multiple sections.

On Thursday, police arrested Kaushik Reddy from his residence in Kondapur, sparking further protests. Earlier, Harish Rao and other BRS leaders were also detained while visiting Reddy's residence and held at Gachibowli police station for several hours.

The incident has escalated tensions between the police and BRS leaders, with allegations of misuse of power.

HC Bars Arrest of Harish Rao in Phone Tapping Case



TPN, Hyderabad: In a major relief to senior Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) leader and former minister T. Harish Rao, the Telangana High Court on Thursday issued interim orders barring the police from arresting him in the phone tapping case until further notice.

The High Court passed these orders based on a petition filed by Harish Rao, seeking the quashing of the case registered against him at Panjagutta Police Station. While granting interim relief, the court directed the police to continue their investigation and instructed Harish Rao to cooperate with the probe.

The case was filed following a complaint by Congress leader and real estate businessman Chakradhar Goud, who alleged harassment, threats, and unlawful phone surveillance. Goud claimed that during the Assembly elections last year, Harish Rao, along with retired police officer Radhakishan Rao and others, conspired to tap his phone and those of 20 family members. He accused Harish Rao of holding a grudge against him due to his charitable activities, including financial support to families of farmers who had committed suicide.

The Panjagutta Police registered a case under multiple sections of the IPC, including 120(B) (criminal conspiracy), 386 (extortion), 409 (criminal breach of trust), and 506 (criminal intimidation), as well as Section 66 of the Information Technology Act.

Harish Rao has denied the allegations, blaming Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy for orchestrating the case to tarnish his reputation. The former minister claimed he was being targeted for exposing the Chief Minister's alleged failures and injustices. The High Court also issued a notice to the complainant, Chakradhar Goud, and adjourned the hearing. Further developments are awaited as the investigation continues.



High Court Directs Action on Midday Meal Safety in **Telangana Schools**

The High Court, acknowledging the concerns, adjourned the case for six weeks, directing the submission of detailed reports and assurances of improved monitoring and safety standards in the meal program.

Devendra Fadnavis Returns as Maharashtra CM Amid BJP's Historic Win

Imran Khan vs a broken system: what's going on in Pakistan

In the early hours of November 26, Islamabad's D-Chowk became a volatile flashpoint of political unrest as thousands of Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) supporters gathered, undeterred by the looming threat of state repression. Tear gas and baton charges could not sway the determined crowds, who were united by one demand—the release of their leader, Imran Khan.

The protests were sparked by Khan's powerful call for nationwide demonstrations, urging Pakistanis to take to the streets to resist what he claimed was an illegitimate political system. Khan, who was recently ousted as Prime Minister, called the electoral process a "stolen mandate" and accused the government of arbitrary arrests and heavy-handed tactics to consolidate power. His grievances were further exacerbated by the controversial 26th Constitutional Amendment, which he argued entrenched a "dictatorial regime" in the country.

At D-Chowk, a symbolic site of political resistance, PTI supporters raised their voices against the government's actions, echoing Khan's accusations of election manipulation and the systematic erosion of democratic norms. Clad in party colors and waving banners calling for Khan's release, the protesters were steadfast in their belief that their leader's imprisonment was a politically motivated move aimed at silencing opposition. Despite the government's efforts to quell the unrest, the protests quickly spread across the country, reflecting



the growing discontent with the ruling coalition.

Khan's supporters voiced their frustrations not only with the political situation but also with the broader governance issues that they believed were undermining Pakistan's democratic institutions. The demonstrations came after months of political upheaval, which saw Khan's government ousted by a no-confidence vote earlier in the year. Since then, the former prime minister has become a rallying figure for those disillusioned by the political establishment.

As security forces moved in to disperse the crowds, tensions escalated, and violent clashes between police and protesters broke out. The situation remains fluid, with both sides entrenched in their positions. For PTI supporters, this is a fight for the future of democracy in Pakistan, while for the government, it is a battle to maintain control in the face of increasing political volatility.

Revanth Reddy led Congress: A Year of Challenges and Achievements

The slogans of 'Tiger Revanth Anna' echoed along the route, marking the return of Revanth Reddy, then a Telugu Desam Party (TDP) MLA, after he was released on bail following his 30-day imprisonment in a bribery case. Despite media ridicule of the event, it marked a significant political moment for Revanth Reddy and his rise in Telangana's political landscape.

Fast forward almost a decade, and it is worth revisiting this moment in the context of the Reddy-led Congress government, which is celebrating its first year in office. The tenure, however, has been far from smooth. While the government took office with much fanfare, it faced numerous challenges that hampered its ability to govern effectively for a full year. The biggest obstacle came in the form of the Lok Sabha election code of conduct, which halted many development and welfare initiatives temporarily.

Despite these hurdles, the Congress government, led by Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao's close ally, Revanth Reddy, has managed to achieve significant milestones within its first year. One of the first major promises fulfilled by the government was the introduction of free bus travel for women in Telangana. This initiative, aimed at empowering women and



easing their mobility, was a landmark step for the administration.

Crisis: President Yoon's Drastic Measure Faces Backlash

A stunning announcement sent shockwaves across South Korea. President Yoon Suk Yeol declared martial law, an unprecedented move in a country where democratic values have been long cherished. The decision, which stunned many South Koreans, prompted lawmakers to rush to the National Assembly, where the opposition led by Lee Jae-myung rejected the martial law in a heated session that lasted for six hours. The imposition was lifted by 4:40 am on December 4, after the assembly's defiance.

Though the announcement was shocking, some had speculated that such an extreme measure could occur, especially given the political turmoil surrounding Yoon's administration. Accusations of corruption, mismanagement, and public dissatisfaction have plagued his presidency, particularly after his handling of the Itaewon crowd disaster and doctors' protests. Further pressure mounted after the opposition gained a majority in the National Assembly in April, which

hindered the government's ability to turned to martial law as a desperate pass legislation and carry out effective governance.

In his martial law declaration, Yoon justified the move by accusing the opposition of creating a "legislature dictatorship" and paralyzing government functions. He claimed the martial law was necessary to protect South Korea from "North Korean communist forces" and to eliminate "pro-Pyongyang antistate forces" that threaten the nation's freedom. His speech also reflected his frustrations with the opposition's increasing demands for accountability over his wife's alleged corruption.

Yoon's decision likely stemmed from intense pressure from multiple fronts, including the opposition, his own party, and his declining popularity. His leadership had already been challenged within his own party by figures like Han Dong-hoon, who urged Yoon to take action. Faced with growing political and public resistance, Yoon

attempt to preserve his presidency.

Following the lifting of martial law, the cabinet resigned en masse, and the ruling People Power Party (PPP) issued a public apology for the crisis. The opposition, however, has not backed down, vowing to initiate impeachment proceedings against Yoon. The impeachment process, requiring support from two-thirds of the National Assembly, could take time but is expected to proceed quickly given the opposition's determination.

This political drama, lasting only six hours, has raised serious questions about South Korea's democratic resilience. The president's future now appears uncertain, and the implications for his party's reputation and political prospects are significant. How the PPP navigates this crisis, particularly if it chooses to support or distance itself from Yoon, will determine the future course of South Korean politics.

Putin's remarks signify the growing partnership between Russia and India, with both nations looking to strengthen their economic ties in a rapidly changing global landscape.

'Nothing Is Safe': Arvind Kejriwal On Delhi Metro Cable Theft

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) National Convenor Arvind Kejriwal took to social media on Thursday to criticize Union Home Minister Amit Shah following a cable theft on the Delhi Metro's Blue Line, which caused significant disruptions for commuters. In a post on X, Kejriwal raised concerns about the safety situation in the capital, saying, "Amit Shah ji, what is happening in Delhi? Even the cable of Delhi Metro has been stolen. Nothing is safe. Do something."

The incident occurred in the early hours of Thursday, when the theft of cables between Moti Nagar and Kirti Nagar stations led to service interruptions on the Blue Line, one of the busiest corridors of the Delhi Metro. Passengers experienced delays as

trains were forced to operate at restricted speeds, causing inconvenience during peak hours.



The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) issued a statement acknowledging the disruption. According to the DMRC, the theft occurred in a section where train services were impacted. They clarified that the situation would be resolved only after operational hours at night, mean-

ing repairs would not be completed during the day. The DMRC's statement also advised commuters to plan their journeys accordingly, as delays were expected throughout the day due to the restricted speed on the affected section. The Blue Line, which connects Dwarka to Noida and Vaishali in Uttar Pradesh, serves several key areas, including Rajiv Chowk, Yamuna Bank, and Mayur Vihar Phase 1, all of which are hubs of business and office activity. As such, the disruption created a significant ripple effect on the daily commute for thousands of passengers.

The Blue Line's importance to the daily functioning of Delhi's transport network makes incidents like these particularly impactful. Kejriwal's comments reflect the growing frustration with the current situation and demand stronger security measures for the city's metro system.

MUDA Case: Notice issued on Karnataka CM's appeal against single bench order

The Karnataka High Court on Thursday issued a notice to the state government and other respondents regarding an appeal filed by Chief Minister Siddaramaiah. He is challenging the single judge bench's decision that upheld the Governor's approval for an investigation into his involvement in the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) site allotment scam.

A division bench, comprising Chief Justice N V Anjaria and Justice K V Aravind, posted the case for further hearing on January 25, 2025.



On October 24, Siddaramaiah filed an appeal against the September 24 order by a single judge bench, which had dismissed his petition. The single judge had upheld the approval granted by Governor Thaawarchand Gehlot for an investigation into the alleged irregularities in the allotment of 14 sites to Siddaramaiah's wife, Parvathi B M, by MUDA.

Siddaramaiah is accused of illegalities in the allotment of these sites, which are located in a prime locality in Mysuru. The controversy centers around the allotment of these 14 sites under a compensatory scheme intended for land losers. Parvathi allegedly had no legal title over the land exchanged for these sites. Despite the allegations, Parvathi requested MUDA to cancel the allotments, and MUDA complied

Following the single judge bench's ruling, a Special Court ordered a Lokayukta police probe into the case, directing the investigation report to be submitted by December 24, 2024. An Enforcement Directorate (ED) investigation has also been initiated, based on the Lokayukta police FIR filed on September 27.

Yogi Adityanath Compares Violence in Sambhal to Historical Divisive Forces

In the midst of ongoing political controversy surrounding the violence in Sambhal, Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath drew a parallel between the western Uttar Pradesh town, Ayodhya, and Bangladesh, highlighting the threat of divisive elements in society. Speaking at the Ramayan Mela in Ayodhya, Adityanath emphasized that Lord Ram's efforts had united society, but warned that conspiracies to divide it had historical roots.

"If we had foiled the conspiracies to divide society, this country would never



have been colonized. Our places of worship would not have been desecrated," Adityanath stated, alluding to the destruction of temples during Muslim rule. He added that the elements causing divisions were still active, with their "genes" continuing in modern-day politics. In a veiled reference to the opposition parties advocating for a caste census, Adityanath criticized those attempting to create divisions in society along caste lines.

The Chief Minister also made a direct comparison between the situation in Sambhal and the recent violence in Bangladesh, where Hindu minorities have faced persecution. He said, "What a general of Babar did in Ayodhya, what happened in Sambhal, and what is happening in Bangladesh today have the same nature and DNA."

PM Modi running away from discussion on Adani issue in Parliament: Priyanka Gandhi

She further added, "The way the prime minister is defending Adani's corruption by breaking all decorum is extremely shocking. Today, along with fellow MPs, I demonstrated on this issue in Parliament premises."

Priyanka Gandhi also participated in the protest wearing a similar black jacket with the protest stickers. Along with her, other opposition MPs staged a march within the Parliament complex, showing their collective demand for a debate on the Adani issue.

The protest stems from allegations of financial misconduct and improper dealings involving the Adani Group, which has been under scrutiny for its ties to the government. The opposition parties, particularly the Congress, have been vocal in demanding an investigation into these allegations, accusing the Modi government of shielding the business conglomerate from scrutiny.

South Korea's President Yoon Faces Impeachment After Martial Law Incident



South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol's presidency has been marred by scandals and political turmoil, and now he faces impeachment after a dramatic incident where he imposed martial law and deployed troops and helicopters to parliament. The country's return to military rule lasted just a few hours, as protests erupted and forced Yoon to reverse his decision in the early hours of Wednesday.

The opposition filed an impeachment motion, accusing the 63-year-old president of "gravely violating the constitution and the law" in a bid to avoid investigations into alleged illegal actions involving him and his family. Yoon, once hailed as a prosecutor and anti-corruption advocate, is now struggling to maintain his grip on power.

Yoon's political career has been marked by controversy. Born in 1960, just before a military coup, Yoon rose to prominence as a public prosecutor, playing a key role in the impeachment of former President Park Geun-hye in 2016. In 2022, he won the presidency by the narrowest margin in South Korean history, but his time in office has been fraught with issues.

Critics have pointed to his administration's handling of the 2022 Halloween crowd crush, food inflation, economic struggles, and increasing restrictions on freedom of speech. He also faced backlash for using presidential vetoes, including blocking a bill that would have investigated alleged stock manipulation by his wife, Kim Keon Hee. His wife later became embroiled in a scandal over receiving a designer handbag, further tarnishing Yoon's reputation. Despite these challenges, Yoon has maintained a tough stance against North Korea and strengthened ties with the United States. However, his attempts to improve relations with Japan have not been well-received domestically.

"Voted In Favour Of 10, Abstained From 3 Gaza Resolutions": S Jaishankar

In a statement delivered in Parliament today, External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar reaffirmed India's long-standing support for a two-state solution to the Israel-Palestine conflict, emphasizing the establishment of a "sovereign, independent, and viable Palestinian state" alongside Israel. Jaishankar responded to claims made during the Rajya Sabha's Question Hour that India had abstained from all United Nations resolutions on Gaza.

Since the onset of the Israel-Hamas conflict on October 7 last year, 13 resolutions concerning Palestine were brought before the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA), Jaishankar explained. India voted in favor of 10 of these resolutions and abstained from tion made in 2023. three. Hasina Accuses Yunus of Genocide and Minority Persecution

In a strong statement delivered virtually from New York, ousted Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina accused the country's interim leader, Muhammad Yunus, of perpetrating "genocide" and failing to protect minorities, particularly Hindus. Hasina's comments, made during an event, added fuel to the already volatile political situation in Bangladesh, where tensions between the government and opposition have escalated in recent months.

Hasina, who was forced to resign in August amid massive anti-government protests, has not been publicly vocal until now. She took shelter in India following her resignation, but her address shed light on the intense political climate she faced in Bangladesh. In her remarks, Hasina alleged that Yunus had not only failed to protect minorities but had also been directly involved in actions that led to the persecution of these communities.

Additionally, Hasina claimed there were plans to assassinate her and her sister, Sheikh Rehana, in a manner similar to the assassination of their father, Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, in 1975. Mujibur Rahman, Bangladesh's founding father, was killed in a coup,



and Hasina's statement pointed to the ongoing threats her family faces from political factions.

Hasina also recounted the events leading up to her departure from the prime minister's residence, Ganabhaban, during the August protests. She described how armed protesters stormed the residence and how, in the face of escalating violence, she was forced to flee the scene. Hasina urged her security guards not to use force, as tensions mounted and the situation threatened to spiral out of control.

The speech marks Hasina's first public address on the crisis since her resignation, and her accusations against Yunus have further polarized the political landscape in Bangladesh.



French Prime Minister Michel Barnier Resigns After No-Confidence Vote

French Prime Minister Michel Barnier has announced his resignation after facing a no-confidence vote that saw support from both far-right and left-wing lawmakers. The vote, held on Wednesday evening, comes amid a growing political crisis that has deepened uncertainty in France, the second-largest economy in the eurozone. Barnier, who was also the European Union's Brexit negotiator, will step down on Thursday, December 5, making him the shortest-serving prime minister in modern French history.

The vote of no confidence was triggered by Barnier's controversial attempt to push through an unpopular budget in a divided and fragmented parliament. The budget, which proposed 60 billion euros (\$63 billion) in savings, was seen as deeply unpopular among many lawmakers, especially those from the left and the far right. Barnier's decision to attempt to pass the budget without a proper vote, further alienating members of parliament, contributed to the backlash.

Barnier's resignation marks a significant political shift, as no French government has lost a no-confidence vote in over 50 years. Despite his experience in European politics, Barnier was unable to overcome the parliamentary challenges in France, where his government's ability to pass legislation was increasingly under threat from multiple factions. The situation reflects the ongoing fragmentation of French politics, where deep divisions over budgetary policies and the future direction of the country have created gridlock.

As Barnier prepares to hand in his resignation, the future of the French government remains uncertain. His departure highlights the ongoing difficulties faced by President Emmanuel Macron's administration in managing a deeply divided parliament. With the resignation of Barnier, political observers now turn their attention to what will come next, and how the French government will navigate its way out of this crisis.

"Breaking Glass Ceiling": **Netumbo Namibia's First Woman President**



Netumbo Nandi-Ndaitwah, Namibia's first woman president, declared that her election victory last week had shattered a "glass ceiling" for women in the country. Nandi-Ndaitwah, who has served as vice president since February 2024, won just over 57 percent of the vote, far ahead of her main opponent from the opposition Independent Patriots for Change (IPC), who garnered 25.5 percent. However, the IPC has rejected the results, citing numerous irregularities during the election process.

At her first press briefing after the results were announced, the 72-yearold leader acknowledged the significance of her achievement, calling it a breakthrough for Namibian women. She also recognized Liberia's former president, Ellen Johnson Sirleaf, as an inspiration, noting that Sirleaf was the first female president in Africa in 2006. "Equal responsibility for women and men in society is a reality," she said, reinforcing her stance on gender equality.

Despite her victory, the election has been mired in controversy. Voters faced long delays and frustrations due to logistical issues, including a shortage of ballot papers that led to people waiting for hours, with some giving up after waiting up to 12 hours. The IPC claimed these issues were intentional and designed to frustrate voters, and it has vowed not to accept the results. The Electoral Commission of Namibia admitted to its failures in managing the vote, including problems with the voting tablets and ballot paper shortages.

In her speech, Nandi-Ndaitwah promised a "radical shift" in how the country is governed. She vowed to focus on addressing the challenges faced by vulnerable communities and the downtrodden, signaling a new direction for the country's future leadership. She will officially take office on March 21, 2025.

While her victory marks a significant milestone for women in leadership, it remains clouded by questions regarding the fairness and transparency of the election process.

China's Finished Steel Imports to India Surge, Straining Local Producers

From April to October, China, the world's largest steel producer, exported 1.7 million metric tons of finished steel to India, marking a significant 35.4% increase compared to the same period last year. This sharp rise in imports has intensified the challenges faced by Indian steel producers, who are already dealing with the pressure of cheaper Chinese steel flooding the market.

The influx of Chinese steel has worsened the financial situation for many Indian producers, as they are forced to contend with falling domestic steel prices, despite strong demand spurred by India's rapid economic growth and increasing infrastructure spending. ing action now to end the targeting of junk food ads at kids, across both TV and pre-packaged sugary breakfast foods such online."


