Did Narayana's Interests Shape AP Govt's Move to Scrap 1st Year Inter Exams?

The Andhra Pradesh government's decision to abolish 1st Year Intermediate exams has ignited widespread discussions, with critics questioning the policy's intent and its potential repercussions on the education sector. The proposal, initially led by a senior IAS officer, has drawn mixed reactions, particularly over alleged influences from private education giants.

Genesis of the Policy

The move stemmed from a review led by an IAS officer tasked with evaluating disparities in Intermediate education. During the review, concerns were raised about private institutions like Narayana and Chaitanya monopolizing high-achieving students from the 10th standard, while government colleges often enrolled those with lower grades. This imbalance, the officer argued, led to a stark contrast in educational outcomes between private and government institutions.

An employee of the Intermediate board shared that Education Minister Lokesh, seeking expert insights, directed the IAS officer to meet Minister Narayana, a key figure in the education sector with extensive business interests in Plus 2 institutions. Following the meeting, Minister Narayana arranged for the IAS officer to consult with deans from prominent private colleges, further shaping the proposal to scrap 1st Year Inter exams and introduce new regulations.

Benefiting Private Giants?

Critics are questioning the heavy involvement of private sector representatives in shaping a public education policy. With Minister Narayana himself linked to the education business, some argue the policy might favor established players like Narayana and Chaitanya, enabling them to strengthen their dominance in the sector. Smaller and medium-range colleges, already struggling to compete, could face severe challenges under the new framework, potentially exacerbating the existing monopoly in Intermediate education. Does this policy prioritize the interests of private institutions over the broader goal of equitable education? While some see the policy as a step toward reform, others believe it threatens to deepen the divide between private and government institutions. "The IAS officer's proposal had noble intentions to address systemic gaps, but the involvement of private deans and Minister Narayana has raised concerns about biases," said a source familiar with the discussions.

CM Naidu Announces Release of ₹6,700 Crore **Pending Dues**

In a significant move on the occasion of Sankranthi, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has announced the green signal for the release of thousands of crores, benefiting various sections of society, including students, police, government employees, and small contractors. This decision is seen as a festive gift aimed at alleviating financial burdens and promoting development across the state.

According to Finance Minister Payyavula Keshav, CM Chandrababu has approved the release of pending funds amounting to Rs. 6,700 crore. During a review meeting at the Chief Minister's residence in Undavalli, CM Chandrababu discussed the status of the finance department and instructed the release of several key dues. The key announcements include Rs. 519 crore for government employees under the General Provident Fund (GPF), Rs. 214 crore for police officers' surrender leave arrears, Rs. 300 crore for the Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS), and Rs. 265 crore under Tax Deducted at Source (TDS), bringing a total of Rs. 1,300 crore in payments to employees. Additionally, Rs. 788 crore is being released to six and a half lakh students under the fee reimbursement scheme.

The government will also release Rs. 586

crore to 26,000 small contractors with bills under Rs. 10 lakh, and Rs. 241 crore in rent arrears to Amaravati farmers. Further, Rs. 100 crore will benefit 6,000 small traders, while Rs. 500 crore each will be allocated to NTR medical services and the power department.

Minister Payyavula Keshav highlighted that the government is committed to clearing the dues of Rs. 10 lakh crore left behind by the previous administration under former CM Jagan Mohan Reddy, aiming to steer the state back onto a path of progress. This announcement signals a focused effort to revitalize development in Andhra Pradesh, which had stagnated during the YSRCP regime.

A Threat to Educational Equity?

Many stakeholders worry that abolishing 1st Year Inter exams could lower standards in government colleges while benefiting larger private chains already equipped with resources to adapt quickly. Some inner circles are even calling this a "death note" for smaller colleges struggling to compete in a market dominated by big players.

The Education Department must address these concerns transparently to assure the public of its commitment to equitable education. Is this decision a genuine attempt to reform the Intermediate education system, or has it been influenced by vested interests? The government's ability to manage this controversy will determine the policy's true impact on the state's education landscape.

Dy CM Pawan Kalyan Expresses Happiness Over the Green Co Solar Park Project

In addition to the project's potential economic benefits, Pawan Kalyan encouraged the company to engage in various social welfare activities, including educational programs, organic farming, and the promotion of cattle farming, through its CSR initiatives.

Water Resource Panel **Reviews Polavaram Project Status**

A 15-member parliamentary standing committee on water resources arrived in Andhra Pradesh on Friday to assess the progress of the Polavaram project, a major irrigation initiative on the Godavari River. The committee, led by BJP MP and former Union Minister Rajiv Pratap Rudy, is accompanied by 27 senior officials from the Union Jal Shakti Ministry, including representatives from the Central Water Commission (CWC) and the Polavaram

Project Authority (PPA).

The committee's visit comes as the state government prepares to resume work on the construction of the diaphragm wall (D-wall), a critical component of the project. The state government has revised designs and materials for the D-wall after extensive consultations with domestic and international experts. They are awaiting final clearance from the CWC to begin this work, which is considered the most challenging aspect of the Polavaram project.

A senior official from the state irrigation department stated that the committee's visit is timely, as the state is prepared to restart the D-wall construction. The committee will review the reasons for the delays in the project, particularly the extensive damages caused by the August 2020 floods to the previously constructed D-wall and cofferdams, as well as breaches to the guide bund. During their tour, the committee will address the key concerns impacting the project's progress.







Strengthening Security and Governance The Case for a National Temple Force and

Union Territory Status for Tirumala

The tragic loss during pilgrimages has emerged as a national concern, highlighting the urgent need to implement robust security measures. The establishment of a national temple security force, akin to the Central Industrial Security Force, could be a vital step in safeguarding pil-

grims and ensuring their safety during visits to sacred sites.

A significant issue contributing to the crisis is the ongoing space crunch at pilgrimage sites, which has been exacerbated by encroachment from state governments for electoral gains and by unauthorized individuals. The lack of effective control over these areas calls for the introduction of central laws similar to those that protect defense and forest lands. These laws could help preserve the integrity of pilgrimage spaces and prevent their misuse.

To address these challenges, it may be beneficial to involve paramilitary forces in securing pilgrimage sites, drawing from the rigorous protocols employed at airports. Such measures would not only enhance security but also protect the sanctity of religious offerings, ultimately restoring public trust in the administration's ability to ensure the safety of both the sites and their visitors. In addition to bolstering security,

Margani Bharat Criticizes TTD and Chandrababu, **Demands Accountability for Tirupati Tragedy**



TPN Correspondent, Andhra Pradesh | Jan 12 : YSRCP official spokesperson and Former MP Margani Bharat described the loss of seven lives in the Tirupati stampede as a tragedy and a clear failure of governance. He expressed outrage over the mismanagement by the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD) officials, stating that devotees who came for towithout basic facilities like drinking water. "They couldn't manage a crowd of just 4,000-5,000 people," he said.

Bharat criticized the TTD EO and Chairman for arguing in front of the Chief Minister instead of addressing the crisis. "I don't understand whether this is a temple or a political party office," he remarked. He also questioned Chandrababu Naidu's experience in han-

dling crowds, recalling the Rajahmundry Pushkaram tragedy where 29 people died due to what he termed "Chandrababu's campaign madness." He alleged that such tragic incidents have frequently occurred in programs linked to Chandrababu.

Bharat condemned TTD Chairman B.R. Naidu for dismissing the need to apologize, quoting him as saying, "Will those

kens were locked in a park who died return if I apologize?" Bharat criticized this statement as reflective of the government's disregard for human lives. He pointed out that such incidents never occurred during Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy's tenure.

> Calling for accountability, Bharat demanded a Supreme Court Justice-led inquiry into the incident and urged the resignation of the entire TTD board. He alleged that obstacles were created when opposition leaders attempted to visit the victims.

> Additionally, Bharat accused the government of threatening businessmen and extorting large sums of money. "Should industries be supported or driven out?" he questioned, highlighting the adverse impact on the state's business environment. Bharat's statements further intensified the call for justice and accountability in the aftermath of the Tirupati tragedy.

CPI State Secretary Ramakrishna Demands Apology from Amit Shah for Insulting Ambedkar

TPN Correspondent, Vijayawada | Jan 12 : In Vijayawada, CPI State Secretary K. Ramakrishna strongly condemned Union Home Minister Amit Shah for allegedly insulting Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in Parliament. Ramakrishna demanded that Amit Shah issue a public apology for his remarks and called for continued protests until his resignation.

Roja questioned why, despite several days having passed since the incident, no cases have been registered against those responsible. She criticized the Chief Minister and Deputy Chief Minister for allegedly protecting those accountable for the tragedy, accusing them of disregarding the lives of devotees. "Don't you know that lakhs of devotees visit for Vaikuntha Ekadashi?" she asked.

The YCP leader further questioned why the token system, blamed for the chaos, has not been removed even seven months into the coalition government's tenure. She accused the government of diverting attention from the issue by merely discussing the token system without taking action.

Roja also took aim at Jana Sena Party chief Pawan Kalyan, accusing him of confusing people with his statements. Referring to his recent comments about Allu Arjun, she pointed out that Pawan did not visit the families of two people who died during the 'Game Changer' event. Additionally, Roja criticized BJP state president Daggubati Purandeswari for remaining silent on the stampede and condemned recent comments made by Minister Anam Ramanarayana Reddy as "despicable." She demanded immediate accountability and action to ensure such tragedies are not repeated.

Roja's sharp remarks come amidst mounting criticism of the government's handling of the incident, further intensifying the political discourse around the tragedy.

Criticizing the BJP, Ramakrishna accused the party of disrespecting freedom fighters and undermining the values enshrined in the Constitution. "Ambedkar's Constitution has given rights to everyone today. Yet, the BJP, which claims to respect national figures, has no real regard for freedom fighters like Mahatma Gandhi and Ambedkar," he stated.

He drew comparisons between Veer Savarkar, whom he described as a "person who surrendered to the British," and Mahatma Gandhi, who "fought relentlessly until India gained independence." Ramakrishna alleged that the BJP is misleading the public with Modi's "deceptive words and lies."

Highlighting the BJP's alleged misuse of power, he accused the party of filing cases against opposition leaders to suppress



dissent. "The BJP is killing the sovereignty of the people and fostering communalism," Ramakrishna remarked.

Ramakrishna also criticized Andhra Pradesh leaders, claiming that despite Ambedkar being the foundation for the political opportunities they have enjoyed, they have failed to defend him. "Chandrababu Naidu, Pawan Kalyan, and Jagan Mohan Reddy have not uttered a single word in protest. They bow before Modi, even when injustice is done to Andhra Pradesh," he said.

Calling the situation in Andhra Pradesh unique and deeply troubling, Ramakrishna emphasized that major political parties in the state are unable to condemn even direct insults to Ambedkar. He reiterated his demand for an apology from Amit Shah, asserting that the CPI would continue its struggle to uphold the values of justice and equality.

He expressed outrage that police and officials allegedly delayed access to the hospital for Jagan until his scheduled arrival.

Highlighting the seriousness of the situation, Bhumana emphasized that the focus should be on supporting the victims and ensuring justice rather than engaging in political blame games. His remarks have added to the ongoing political debate surrounding the Tirupati stampede and its aftermath.



Food Safety Standards

Why ShouldIt Take Three Days to Declare Delhi **Assembly Election Results?**

Oⁿ January 7, the Election Commission of India (ECI) announced that polling for the Delhi Assembly elections will take place on February 5, with results to be declared on February 8. This three-day gap between polling and results has raised questions, especially considering the relatively small size and urban nature of Delhi, which has only 70 constituencies.

A key argument often made in favor of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) is that they allow for faster result declaration compared to traditional paper ballots, which are time-consuming to count. In multi-phase elections across larger, rural areas, the time taken to transport EVMs from distant polling stations to counting centers is often cited as the reason for delayed results.

However, Delhi's geography presents a different scenario. The state is largely urbanized, and all villages are well-connected by good roads. Even if polling extends until late evening on February 5 due to long queues, the transportation of EVMs to counting centers by the following morning, February 6, should be feasible. Count-



ing could commence early in the day, and results could easily be declared by noon.

The Election Commission of India (ECI) announced that Delhi Assembly election results will be declared on February 8, three days after voting on February 5. Given Delhi's small size and urban infrastructure, this delay seems

unnecessary. Unlike rural areas with distant polling stations, Delhi's well-connected roads should allow EVMs to reach counting centers by the morning of February 6, enabling results by noon. Even in the unlikely event of a repoll, results for the remaining constituencies could be declared on the same day, making the threeday wait questionable and inefficient.

In most cases, an extra day is reserved for unforeseen circumstances, such as a repoll in a constituency. However, the situation in Delhi doesn't justify the three-day delay for result declaration. If a repoll were needed, the results for the remaining constituencies could still be announced on the same day by withholding results from only one or two constituencies.

Two key factors point to a different reason for the delayed result announcement. Firstly, the Election Commission's track record suggests a pattern of delays in the declaration of results, even when logistical reasons do not fully justify the delay. Secondly, the potential for a repoll is extremely unlikely in Delhi, and even if it occurs, it would only affect a few constituencies, making it possible to announce the majority of results on the same day.

Given these factors, the decision to declare the results on February 8 seems unnecessary and raises questions about the efficiency of the process.

This growing digital space has raised alarm bells as it becomes a fertile ground for extremist propaganda, particularly among vulnerable groups.

However, the same Taliban, who have long viewed sports as a distraction from religious duties and an obstacle to enforcing their ideology, are likely to be disheartened by recent calls from British politicians and South Africa's sports minister. They have urged the ICC to ban Afghanistan's men's cricket team from participating in the Champions Trophy, scheduled for February 19 in Pakistan and Dubai. The demand for England and South Africa to boycott their matches against Afghanistan reflects growing international pressure over the Taliban's harsh restrictions on Afghan women, adding



to the regime's frustrations. But banning Afghanistan's cricket team is not an act of justice—it is an endorsement of oppression.

Since the Taliban regained power, Afghanistan has faced a mass exodus, with over 8 million Afghans fleeing due to poverty, economic collapse, and repression. Those who remain have little hope, living under the Taliban's stringent policies that have stifled opportunity and progress. Amid this bleak reality, cricket has become one of the few outlets for joy, inspiration, and resistance. For countless Afghan youth, players like Rashid Khan and Mohammad Nabi embody the possibility of a better future, offering an alter-

native to the extremism of groups like ISKP. Stripping Afghanistan of its cricketing platform would not only crush these dreams but could also push vulnerable young people toward radicalization, posing a potential global security threat.

Afghan cricketers are not just athletes; they are brave symbols of resistance. Many have used their platform to speak out for women's rights, particularly advocating for

the right to education in defiance of the Taliban's oppressive policies. Their public statements, social media posts, and even silent protests demonstrate remarkable courage in a regime where dissent is punishable by death. These players risk everything to stand up for the rights of Afghan women, making them champions of more than just sport.

Banning Afghanistan's cricket team would not only be a blow to the nation's morale but also a victory for the forces of repression. Supporting Afghanistan's cricketers is supporting a brighter, more inclusive future for the country.

He pointed out that he was not invited to a meeting with the negotiating committee, leading him to believe the purpose of the talks is merely to delay the response to the November 26 killings. He expressed his frustration over the government's inability to form a judicial commission, which he believes is essential to investigating the tragic events and bringing justice to those who were killed or disappeared during the violence.



The Adani Group, through its subsidiary Adani Commodities LLP, completed the Offer for Sale (OFS), which also included an option to sell up to 8.44 crore additional shares, representing 6.5% equity.

The total number of shares up for sale in the transaction could rise to 19.51 crore, representing 15.01% of Adani Wilmar's total issued capital, including an oversubscription The proceeds from this sale will option of 1.51%. 16th-Century Royal Burial Regalia Discovered in Vilnius Cathedral

Aremarkable dis-covery has been made in the Vilnius Cathedral in Lithuania, where royal burial regalia from the 16th century were recovered after being concealed for nearly a century. These invaluable artefacts, including crowns, rings, chains, a sceptre, and coffin plaques, were hidden in a crypt at the onset of

World War II. The items, once belonging to influential figures from the Grand Duchy of Lithuania and the Kingdom of Poland, offer significant insight into the region's historical and cultural heritage.

The discovery took place on December 16, 2024, when a team of experts, using an endoscopic camera, explored the cathedral's underground chambers. The artefacts were first uncovered in 1931 during restoration work following a flood that exposed royal sarcophagi. However, in 1939, as World War II loomed, the regalia were hidden for safekeeping to protect them from potential looting or destruction. Among the treasures are burial ornaments associated with Alexander Jagiellon, the Grand Duke of Lithuania and King of Poland, as well as two queens: Elisabeth of Austria and Barbara Radziwiłł.

These artefacts hold immense historical value, particularly since authentic items from this era are scarce in Lithuania. The families



of these royals played a vital role during the Polish Renaissance, contributing to the cultural and political landscape of the time. Mykolas Sotincenka, communications coordinator for the Vilnius Archdiocese, emphasized the rarity and significance of these relics, which offer a glimpse into the past.

Archbishop Gintaras Grušas referred to the regalia as "priceless historical treasures" and praised them for their exceptional craftsmanship in goldsmithing and jewellery. During the recovery, a newspaper from September 1939 was found wrapped around the items, confirming their deliberate concealment during the war. Rita Pauliukevičiūtė, director of the Vilnius Church Heritage Museum, noted that these artefacts symbolize Lithuania's historical strength.

Efforts to document and restore the regalia are underway, with plans to publicly display them later this year, allowing visitors to appreciate these extraordinary pieces of history.

Paris, We Are Coming: Pakistan International Airlines Ad Misfires, Memes Fly On X

 $\mathbf{P}^{\mathrm{akistan}}$ International Airlines (PIA) found itself at the center of an unexpected social media storm after posting a promotional message about resuming flights between Islamabad and Paris. What was intended to be a celebratory announcement quickly turned into the subject of memes and criticism when the airline shared an image showing a plane seemingly heading toward Paris, with the Eiffel Tower in the background, accompanied by the caption, "Paris, we are coming today."

The post was meant to mark the relaunch of flights between the two cities on January 10, 2025, following the European Union's decision to lift restrictions on PIA. However, the choice of words and imagery unintentionally evoked memories of one of the most tragic events in modern history: the 9/11 terrorist attacks. Social media users quickly drew comparisons between the promotional message and the infamous phrase "We are coming today" used in the context of the tragic events that unfolded in 2001.

As a result, the post attracted a flurry of memes, jokes, and sharp criticism, with many questioning the tone and timing of the announcement. While PIA likely intended to celebrate its return to European skies after a long hiatus, the execution of the message backfired, prompting online users to make light of the



situation and share their own interpretations.

The airline's social media blunder highlights the risks of using powerful imagery and phrases without considering how they might be perceived by a wider audience. The ad's unintended connection to 9/11 led to a wave of reactions, both humorous and critical, on social media platforms like X (formerly Twitter).

This incident serves as a reminder of how sensitive topics and imagery can evoke unintended associations, especially in the age of social media where even a seemingly harmless post can quickly go viral and spark controversy. Despite the backlash, the attention PIA received also underscores the power of social media in shaping public discourse, for better or worse.






