Telangana to Issue New Ration Cards from Jan 26th

Minister Srinivas Reddy further elaborated that, in addition to the ration cards, the state would also provide homes under the Indiramma Housing Scheme for the eligible poor. He confirmed that 3,500 homes have already been allocated for a specific segment of the population, and in the coming four phases, financial assistance of ₹5 lakh each would be provided to beneficiaries.

In a separate matter, Minister Ponguleti criticized BRS Working President K. T. Rama Rao's recent comments regarding the 'Formula E Car' race case. He described KTR's remarks as unnecessary, suggesting that accusations against the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) and Enforcement Directorate (ED) in their investigations into BRS ministers' actions were base-

He emphasized that the Congress government was not targeting any individual, but rather letting the law take its course.Minister Srinivas Reddy concluded by urging that KTR should refrain from blaming investigation agencies for their actions, emphasizing that his government would ensure fair investigations without political interference.

Sankranti Fare Hike: Emptying Wallets for Village Trips!

TPN Correspondent, Telangana, Jan 12:As Sankranti festival approaches, people from urban areas are flocking to their villages to celebrate with family. However, traveling to rural areas is becoming increasingly expensive. The festive rush has led to a significant hike in transportation fares, leaving commuters frustrated and their wallets lighter.

- RTC Bus Fare Hike: The Andhra Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation (APSRTC) has kept the regular fares unchanged, unlike Telangana State Road Transport Corporation (TSRTC), which has imposed a 50% surcharge on fares for special buses. This disparity has sparked protests among travelers, with many opting for APSRTC buses heading towards Andhra Pradesh due to the lower fares. TSRTC is operating 6,432 buses during this period, while APSRTC is running 7,200 buses, with the majority coming from Hyderabad. Special buses have been prepared for the 11th and 12th of January to accommodate the passenger rush.
- Private Bus Fare Surge: Private travel services have taken advantage of the high demand by hiking fares drastically. Buses heading to major cities like Rajahmundry, Visakhapatnam, and Tirupati have seen price increases of up to four times. For instance, the fare from Hyderabad to Rajahmundry has surged to a maximum of Rs. 4,000, while to Visakhapatnam, it has gone up to Rs. 6,000. For destinations like Adilabad, fares range from Rs. 5,000 to Rs. 6,000.
- · Ticket Booking Woes: For those attempting to book tickets, they are facing disappointment as many buses are fully booked or the prices have gone up steeply. In the case of Vijayawada, the fare for a super luxury bus has increased from Rs. 440 to Rs. 660 for special buses. The high demand and limited availability are making it difficult for many to secure seats.
- Increased Airfare: In addition to the bus fare hikes, air travel has also become more expensive. On Friday morning, the airfare from Hyderabad to Vijayawada was over Rs. 14,000, while the fare to Rajahmundry was around Rs. 22,000, further straining travelers' budgets.

With transportation costs escalating across different modes of travel, Sankranti travelers are feeling the financial strain as they make their way home for the festival.

Five Youth Drown in Kondapochamma Sagar Reservoir



TPN Correspondent, Siddipet, Jan 12: A tragic incident occurred in Siddipet district, where five young individuals lost their lives while swimming in Kondapochamma Sagar Dam. Seven youths had ventured into the dam for a swim, but five of them drowned, while two others managed to escape with their lives.

The deceased youths were identified as Dhanush (20), Lohith (17), Dineshwar (17), Sahil (19), and Jatin (17), all residents of Musheerabad in Hyderabad. The surviving youths, Mrigank (17) and Ibrahim (20), were able to make it out of the water safely.

KTR Slams Telangana Govt for Covering Up Sunkishala Report

TPN Correspondent, Hyderabad, Jan 12:Telangana Minister K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) has strongly criticized the state government for refusing to release the vigilance report on the Sunkishala incident, which resulted in the collapse of a retaining wall and a loss of ₹80 crore in public funds. He condemned the government for withholding the report under the Right to Information (RTI) Act, calling it a "disastrous" and "unjust" action.

KTR accused the government of hiding the truth to protect Megha Engineering & Infrastructures Ltd. (Megha), the construction

company responsible for the failure. He claimed that the political gain after coming to power. government had linked the issue to national security laws

to prevent the disclosure of the committee's findings. He also stated that the government's reluctance to make the report public was an attempt to cover up the flaws in the construction and avoid political embarrassment.

Further, KTR alleged that there was a secret political deal between Chief Minister Revanth Reddy and Megha Krishna Reddy, which is the main reason behind suppressing the report. He pointed out that Revanth Reddy, who had previously accused Megha of being corrupt when in the opposition, now appeared to be protecting the company for personal and

Traffic Chaos in Uppal, Nagol, Boduppal, and LB Nagar Roads Amid Sankranti Rush

BRS Delays Nalgonda Farmers' Protest, Plans Post-Sankranti Rally

TPN Correspondent, Nalgonda, Jan 12:In a key decision, the Telangana Rashtra Samithi (BRS) has postponed the planned farmers' Mahadharna (mass protest) scheduled for Sunday in Nalgonda district. The party announced that the protest would be delayed to avoid causing inconvenience to the public during the Sankranti festival season, citing travel difficulties and road congestion. BRS leaders assured that the Mahadharna would be held on a larger scale after Sankranti.

BRS district president Ravinder Kumar, former Zilla Parishad chairman Banda Narender Reddy, ex-MLAs Nallamothu Bhaskar Rao, Chirumarti Lingayya, and Kancherla Bhoopal Reddy spoke to the media, explaining the reasons behind the delay. They emphasized that the decision was made in consideration of the festival-related travel and road congestion. They also declared that after Sankranti, they would expose the failures of the Congress party.

The BRS leaders reminded the public of the Congress party's unfulfilled promises, highlighting issues like the reduction of farmer support from ₹15,000 to ₹12,000 and the incomplete implementation of the ₹2 lakh loan waiver scheme. The Case for a National Temple Force and Union Territory Status for Tirumala

By Dr. Buragadda Srinadh : The tragic loss of lives during pilgrimages has emerged as a national concern, highlighting the urgent need to implement robust security measures. The establishment of a national temple security force, akin to the Central Industrial Security Force, could be a vital step in safeguarding pilgrims and ensuring their safety during visits to sacred sites.

A significant issue contributing to the crisis is the ongoing space crunch at pilgrimage sites, which has been exacerbated by encroachment from state governments for electoral gains and by unauthorized individuals. The lack of effective control over these areas calls for the introduction of central laws similar to those that protect defense and forest lands. These laws

could help preserve the integrity of pilgrimage spaces and prevent their misuse.

To address these challenges, it may be beneficial to involve paramilitary forces in securing pilgrimage sites, drawing from the rigorous protocols employed at airports. Such measures would not only enhance security but also protect the sanctity of religious offerings, ultimately restoring public trust in the administration's ability to ensure the safety of both the sites and their visitors.

In addition to bolstering security, one potential solution to the governance challenges at pilgrimage sites is to designate Tirumala as a Union Territory. This change could lead to a more direct and accountable administration, free from the

political influence that has hindered efficient management. The move would provide a transparent and effective governance model, ensuring resources are allocated fairly and used appropriately, without local political pressures distorting priorities.

Over recent decades, the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) has been a focal point for political debate, particularly regarding allegations of misappropriation of funds meant for the upkeep of the temple. These accusations, often tied to a Union Territory, could lead to a the political appointment of board members, have resulted in a lack framework. This change, coupled of accountability, creating a cycle of disputes that diverts attention from the essential need for reform. The situation demands a comprehensive approach that addresses not only security concerns but also



governance and accountability issues. Exploring alternative solutions, such as making Tirumala more responsible management with stronger security measures, would help ensure that pilgrimage sites are effectively governed and protected, providing a safer and more transparent experience for all devotees.

STF Seizes 1050 Kgs of Sugar and 50 Kgs Palm Jaggery in Nalgonda

Bodies of Five Missing Youths Found

The authorities launched a search operation that lasted for about six hours. The first body to be recovered was that of Dinesh, followed by the recovery of other bodies. The final body to be recovered was that of Lohit. The victims have been identified as Dinesh, Dhanush, Jatin, Lohit, and Sahil. Mrigank and Ibrahim survived the tragic accident. The

bodies of the deceased were later sent to Gajwel Government Hospital for post-mortem.

The incident has left the families and the local community devastated, as the youths, all from Musheerabad, were full of life and had gone for a fun trip that turned into a horrific disaster. Authorities have urged citizens to exercise caution when engaging in water-related activ-

Why ShouldIt Take Three Days to Declare Delhi **Assembly Election Results?**

On January 7, the Election Commission of India (ECI) announced that polling for the Delhi Assembly elections will take place on February 5, with results to be declared on February 8. This three-day gap between polling and results has raised questions, especially considering the relatively small size and urban nature of Delhi, which has only 70 constituencies.

A key argument often made in favor of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) is that they allow for faster result declaration compared to traditional paper ballots, which are time-consuming to count. In multi-phase elections across larger, rural areas, the time taken to transport EVMs from distant polling stations to counting centers is often cited as the reason for delayed results.

However, Delhi's geography presents a different scenario. The state is largely urbanized, and all villages are well-connected by good roads. Even if polling extends until late evening on February 5 due to long queues, the transportation of EVMs to counting centers by the following morning, February 6, should be feasible. Count-



ing could commence early in the day, and results could easily be declared by noon.

The Election Commission of India (ECI) announced that Delhi Assembly election results will be declared on February 8, three days after voting on February 5. Given Delhi's small size and urban infrastructure, this delay seems

unnecessary. Unlike rural areas with distant polling stations, Delhi's well-connected roads should allow EVMs to reach counting centers by the morning of February 6, enabling results by noon. Even in the unlikely event of a repoll, results for the remaining constituencies could be declared on the same day, making the threeday wait questionable and inefficient.

In most cases, an extra day is reserved for unforeseen circumstances, such as a repoll in a constituency. However, the situation in Delhi doesn't justify the three-day delay for result declaration. If a repoll were needed, the results for the remaining constituencies could still be announced on the same day by withholding results from only one or two constituencies.

Two key factors point to a different reason for the delayed result announcement. Firstly, the Election Commission's track record suggests a pattern of delays in the declaration of results, even when logistical reasons do not fully justify the delay. Secondly, the potential for a repoll is extremely unlikely in Delhi, and even if it occurs, it would only affect a few constituencies, making it possible to announce the majority of results on the same day.

Given these factors, the decision to declare the results on February 8 seems unnecessary and raises questions about the efficiency of the pro-

Social Media's Dark Side: Fueling Radicalisation in Bangladesh

 $B_{\text{encing rapid digitisation, is}}^{\text{angladesh, a country experiencing rapid digitisation, is}}$ facing a growing concern: online radicalisation. While the widespread use of social media platforms marks a significant step towards progress, it has also opened the door for extremist groups to exploit these spaces, potentially turning them into breeding grounds for radical ideologies.

The country has a vast and

growing digital footprint, with over 52 million users on Facebook, more than 33 million active viewers on YouTube, and at least 1.69 million users on X (formerly Twitter). These platforms, while offering opportunities for communication and information sharing, are increasingly being used by radical groups to spread their ideologies. This growing digital space has raised alarm bells as it becomes a fertile ground for extremist

A recent survey by Bangladesh Police sheds light on the alarming extent of online radicalisation. The survey, which involved 250 jailed militants, found that 82 per cent of the individuals had been radicalised via social

propaganda, particularly among vul-

nerable groups.

media. This statistic underscores the significant role that online platforms play in the radicalisation process,

where extremist groups leverage so-

cial media to influence, recruit, and

groom individuals, particularly young

people, into adopting extremist views.

Urban centres such as Dhaka, Chittagong, Sylhet, Khulna, and Rajshahi are particularly vulnerable to this phenomenon. These cities, with their large populations and high levels of internet connectivity, serve as hotspots for online radicalisation. The youth, in particular, are the most susceptible to the influence of extremist ideologies, as they navigate the com-

Addressing this issue requires a multifaceted approach, focusing on both prevention and intervention, to ensure that social media remains a platform for positive engagement and not a tool for spreading extremism.

Banning Afghanistan cricket from Champions Trophy will be a gift to Taliban

Afghanistan's impressive performances in the 2023 ICC Men's Cricket World Cup and the 2024 Men's T20 World Cup ignited celebrations across the country, from the bustling streets of Kabul to remote villages. CAG Report Exposes Kejriwal: JP Nadda

BJP president J.P. Nadda on Saturday accused the Delhi government of causing a loss of Rs 2,026 crore to the exchequer due to "intentional lapses" in the implementation of its excise policy, as highlighted in a report by the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG).

Nadda, addressing the media on social media platform X, slammed the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government for its handling of the excise policy, saying, "Intoxicated by power, high on misgovernance. 'AAP'DA model of loot in full display and that too on something like liquor." He further added that it was only a matter of time before the AAP government would be voted out and held accountable for what he termed "misdeeds."

The CAG report, which has not yet been officially released, reportedly sheds light on significant financial mismanagement under the Delhi government's excise policy, claiming that lapses in policy implementation resulted in the loss of over Rs 2,000 crore. This comes amidst the ongoing investigation into the alleged corruption related to the policy. The Enforcement Directorate had previously arrested Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and his deputy Manish Sisodia in connection with the excise scam. Both were later released on bail after spending months in custody.

In response to these allegations, AAP Rajya Sabha MP Sanjay Singh questioned the validity of the CAG report, stating, "Where is the report? The BJP keeps claiming that no CAG report has been tabled." Singh's remarks suggest a level of skepticism surrounding the BJP's claims.

The controversy surrounding the excise policy has sparked intense political debate, with the BJP calling for accountability, while the AAP denies the allegations. As the issue continues to unfold, the political temperature in Delhi is set to rise in the lead-up to the upcoming elections.

Afghan Taliban Refuses To Attend Muslim Girls Education Summit In Pakistan

The Afghan Taliban govl ernment has decided not to attend a global summit focused on girls' education in the Muslim world, which was hosted by neighboring Pakistan. Islamabad extended an invitation to Afghanistan, but no representatives from the Afghan government were present at the conference, according to Pakistani Education Minister Khalid Maqbool Siddiqui.

Imran Khan Urges Transparency: Addresses Lawyers And Media From Jail

 Llawyers and media inside Adiala Jail, incarcerated former Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan reiterated his call for a transparent investigation into the violence surrounding the November 26 Islamabad massacre and the May 9 incidents. Khan demanded the formation of a judicial commission to probe these cases, stressing the importance of impartiality in delivering justice.

Khan criticized the ongoing negotiations in Pakistan, claiming that the lack of seriousness from the government is evident. He pointed out that he was not invited to a meeting with the negotiating committee, leading him to believe the purpose of the talks is merely to delay the response to the November 26 killings. He expressed his frustration over the government's inability to form a judicial commission, which he believes is essential to investigating the tragic events and bringing justice to those who were killed or disappeared during the violence.

In his statement, Khan called for a transparent investigation into both the November 26 and May 9 incidents, highlighting the brutal treatment

He mentioned that despite their repeated attempts to seek justice through the local judicial system, they were left with no choice but to raise these human rights violations on international platforms. He urged his lawyers to take these issues to global forums, asserting that Pakistan is bound by international human rights laws and treaties.

Khan also touched on Paki-

stan's deteriorating economic situation, quoting a World Bank report that revealed another 13 million people had fallen below the poverty line. He expressed concern over the country's political and economic instability, which he blamed on institutions, including the judiciary and law enforcement agencies, being politicized and weaponized against PTI. Khan warned that as long as political instability persists, Pakistan's growth rate would remain stagnant, making it impossible to address the nation's economic challenges. He concluded by criticizing the government's actions, which he believes are part of a broader plan to establish a ten-year dictatorship.

This Hit Extreme: Mark Says Biden Govt Pressured **Facebook To Censor Covid vaccine Info**

Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg revealed on Friday that the Biden administration exerted pressure on Facebook to censor content related to Covid-19 vaccines, particularly information discussing vaccine side effects. Zuckerberg made these comments during an appearance on the Joe Rogan Podcast, where he discussed several issues, including government censorship.

According to Zuckerberg, the pressure from the Biden administration reached its peak during the rollout of the Covid-19 vaccination campaign. He explained, "This hit the most extreme. I'd say it was during the Biden Administration when they were trying to roll out the vaccine programme. Now I'm generally pretty pro rolling out vaccines, I think on balance the vaccines are more positive than negative, but I think that while they're trying to push that program, they also tried to censor anyone who was arguing against it."

Zuckerberg clarified that while he supported the vaccine effort, he found it trou-

bling that the government pushed Facebook to remove content that questioned the safety or potential side effects of the vaccine. He described the government's approach as a push to take down "things that were honestly true," adding that the administration pressured Facebook to remove posts discussing vaccine side

effects. "They pushed us super hard to take down things that were honestly true. I mean, they basically pushed us and said, 'You know anything that says that vaccines might have side effects, you need to take down," Zuckerberg recalled.

While Zuckerberg stressed his general support for the vaccine program, he was firm in his stance against censoring factual information. He said, "I was just like, well, we're not going to do that," emphasizing that Facebook would not comply with requests to remove truthful content about vaccine side effects.

The comments sparked debate around the balance between public health measures and freedom of speech, raising questions about the role of social media platforms in moderating content under government pressure. The revelations come at a time when both tech companies and government agencies are under increased scrutiny regarding content moderation practices.

According to a stock exchange filing, the sale involved 17.54 crore shares (13.5% equity) being sold to non-retail investors on January 12, with the offer to retail investors opening on January 13 at a floor price of Rs 275 per share. The Adani Group, through its subsidiary Adani Commodities LLP, completed the Offer for Sale (OFS), which also included an option to sell up to 8.44 crore additional shares, representing 6.5% equity.

The total number of shares up for sale in the transaction could rise to 19.51 crore, representing 15.01% of Adani Wilmar's total issued capital, including an oversubscription The proceeds from this sale will option of 1.51%. This transaction reflects the Adani Group's ability to raise capital successfully, regardless of broader market conditions. The group has now raised a total of \$3.15 billion in equity capital this

16th-Century Royal Burial Regalia Discovered in Vilnius Cathedral

Aremarkable discovery has been made in the Vilnius Cathedral in Lithuania, where royal burial regalia from the 16th century were recovered after being concealed for nearly a century. These invaluable artefacts, including crowns, rings, chains, a sceptre, and coffin plaques, were hidden in a crypt at the onset of

World War II. The items, once belonging to influential figures from the Grand Duchy of Lithuania and the Kingdom of Poland, offer significant insight into the region's historical and cultural heritage.

The discovery took place on December 16, 2024, when a team of experts, using an endoscopic camera, explored the cathedral's underground chambers. The artefacts were first uncovered in 1931 during restoration work following a flood that exposed royal sarcophagi. However, in 1939, as World War II loomed, the regalia were hidden for safekeeping to protect them from potential looting or destruction. Among the treasures are burial ornaments associated with Alexander Jagiellon, the Grand Duke of Lithuania and King of Poland, as well as two queens: Elisabeth of Austria and Barbara Radziwiłł.

These artefacts hold immense historical value, particularly since authentic items from this era are scarce in Lithuania. The families

of these royals played a vital role during the Polish Renaissance, contributing to the cultural and political landscape of the time. Mykolas Sotincenka, communications coordinator for the Vilnius Archdiocese, emphasized the rarity and significance of these relics, which offer a glimpse into the past.

Archbishop Gintaras Grušas referred to the regalia as "priceless historical treasures" and praised them for their exceptional craftsmanship in goldsmithing and jewellery. During the recovery, a newspaper from September 1939 was found wrapped around the items, confirming their deliberate concealment during the war. Rita Pauliukevičiūtė, director of the Vilnius Church Heritage Museum, noted that these artefacts symbolize Lithuania's historical strength.

Efforts to document and restore the regalia are underway, with plans to publicly display them later this year, allowing visitors to appreciate these extraordinary pieces of history.

Paris, We Are Coming: **Pakistan International Airlines** Ad Misfires, Memes Fly On X

Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) found itself at the center of an unexpected social media storm after posting a promotional message about resuming flights between Islamabad and Paris. What was intended to be a celebratory announcement quickly turned into the subject of memes and criticism when the airline shared an image showing a plane seemingly heading toward Paris, with the Eiffel Tower in the background, accompanied by the caption, "Paris, we are coming today."

The post was meant to mark the relaunch of flights between the two cities on January 10, 2025, following the European Union's decision to lift restrictions on PIA. However, the choice of words and imagery unintentionally evoked memories of one of the most tragic events in modern history: the 9/11 terrorist attacks. Social media users quickly drew comparisons between the promotional message and the infamous phrase "We are coming today" used in the context of the tragic events that unfolded in 2001.

As a result, the post attracted a flurry of memes, jokes, and sharp criticism, with many questioning the tone and timing of the announcement. While PIA likely intended to celebrate its return to European skies after a long hiatus, the execution of the message backfired, prompting online users to make light of the



situation and share their own interpretations.

The airline's social media blunder highlights the risks of using powerful imagery and phrases without considering how they might be perceived by a wider audience. The ad's unintended connection to 9/11 led to a wave of reactions, both humorous and critical, on social media platforms like X (formerly Twitter).

This incident serves as a reminder of how sensitive topics and imagery can evoke unintended associations, especially in the age of social media where even a seemingly harmless post can quickly go viral and spark controversy. Despite the backlash, the attention PIA received also underscores the power of social media in shaping public discourse, for better or worse.




