## **CapitaLand to Build ₹450 Crore IT Park in Hyderabad**

### Will Rythu Bharosa Succeed?

Farmers express frustration over reduced aid and strict eligibility criteria.

The Rythu Bharosa scheme, touted as a major welfare initiative by the Telangana government, has drawn sharp criticism from farmers due to reduced financial aid and restrictive conditions. Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's announcement to provide ₹12,000 per acre, instead of the promised ₹15,000, has sparked protests across the state, particularly among those excluded from the scheme.

The government has restricted the scheme to cultivated lands, leaving farmers in drought-hit areas out of its purview. Joint Mahabubnagar district, among others, saw several farmers unable to sow crops last season due to water scarcity, stemming from insufficient Krishna river supply and erratic rainfall. Farmers argue that excluding those unable to cultivate is unfair and amplifies their financial distress.

#### Lack of Clarity on Scheme Implementation

• Only cultivated lands eligible for Confusion over the Rythu Bharosa scheme persists despite government assurances. While Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka has confirmed its rollout from January 26, 2025, doubts remain over acreage limits and eligibility criteria. The government has emphasized transparency, contrasting the scheme with the Rythu Bandhu initiative, which allegedly benefited landlords. However, the absence of concrete guidelines is creating uncertainty among farmers.

On Sunday, Bhatti Vikramarka visited Errupalem Mandal and laid the foundation stone for various infrastructure projects. These included the construction of internal cement roads in Narasimhapuram (Rs. 7 lakh), Buchireddypalem (Rs. 12 lakh), and Banigandlapadu (Rs. 19.25 lakh), along with the inauguration of the Primary Health Center building at Banigandlapadu (Rs. 1.56 crore).

Addressing the public, the Deputy CM expressed happiness over the newly inaugurated Banigandlapadu hospital, emphasizing the importance of the area's development. He mentioned upcoming infrastructure projects, such as a bridge over Kattaleru, a direct road

link from Madhira, and the expansion of key roads in the region, which will boost connectivity.

Bhatti Vikramarka also assured that another 50-bed hospital would be set up at Errupalem Mandal's center to serve the people. In terms of education, the Deputy CM announced plans to restore the junior college building adjacent to the hospital and to submit proposals for its refurbishment.

## Harish Rao Pushes for Increased Ration Card Eligibility

Govt Ignoring Poor: Harish Rao Harish Rao Urges Income Limit Increase Harish Rao Criticizes Ration Card Process

**Hyderabad** | **Jan 20:** BRS MLA Harish Rao expressed strong discontent over the government's handling of ration card distribution, particularly the opposition's protests. He stated that despite these protests, the government should not overlook the needs of the poor. According to Rao, the announcement that ration cards will be issued to public administration applicants is a victory for the BRS. He also called for an increase in the income limit for ration card eligibility, in line with rising inflation.

Rao pointed out that while the government has been slow to address the issue of ration card issuance, the BRS's efforts have ensured that public administration and caste census applications will be considered continuously. He demanded that the government revise the income and land limits for eligibility to reflect current inflation rates.

Under KCR's leadership, the government had previously raised income and land limits for ration cards—rural income limits were increased to Rs. 1.5 lakh, and urban limits to Rs. 2.5 lakh, with land limits also adjusted. However, Rao insisted that further changes are necessary to ensure the poor are not left



behind.Rao also emphasized that employees, low-income groups, and agricultural laborers should be entitled to ration cards. He urged the government to remove restrictions linked to employment and ensure all eligible individuals can benefit from the Indiramma Atmiya Bharosa Scheme.

Rao concluded by urging the government not to impose cuts during the ration card distribution process, which he views as crucial support for the poor.

## Minister Rajanarsimha Defends Health Services

Rajanarsimha on BRS Health Service Failures Health Dues Cleared, Rates Revised, Says Minister Rajanarsimha Rejects Harish Rao's Allegations

**Telangana** Jan 20: Medical and Health Minister Damodar Rajanarsimha has strongly countered the comments made by former BRS Minister Harish Rao regarding the suspension of health services. Rajanarsimha

accused Harish Rao of undermining the Arogya Sri scheme, saying that Harish Rao had been responsible for watering down the scheme during his tenure in the BRS government.



Rajanarsimha further criticized Harish Rao's claims, stating that under the BRS regime, hospitals were not paid, and the prices for medical packages were not revised. He expressed anger over an outstanding amount of approximately Rs. 730 crore left unpaid.

The Minister highlighted that the current Congress government is working to clear these dues and resolve the issues left by the BRS administration. He pointed out that Rs. 1,130 crore had been paid in just one year, including the clearance of the old dues from the BRS period. Additionally, the government has revised the rates of medical packages, increasing charges by 22 percent, and is working to resolve other issues raised by hospital owners.

Rajanarsimha emphasized that his government is committed to ensuring that health services improve and the outstanding payments are cleared as part of their plan to strengthen the healthcare system.



### BJP MP Etala Rajender Criticizes Congress Over Hydra Ruckus

He pointed out that the poor residents of Balajinagar and Jawahar Nagar, who have lived there



for over 40 years, are not illegal occupants. Rajender clarified that the land in question belongs to the Defence Department, originally acquired by the British government, covering 5,877 acres. He noted that the government had allotted land to 1,705 people in Arundhati Nagar, with some land being given to those who had undergone family planning at the time. The BJP MP also highlighted the ongoing land scams in Arundhati Nagar and expressed concern about the fate of the poor. He claimed that if the underprivileged buy land and build homes, the current government would demolish them. His remarks came in response to what he called a disruption created by the Congress government in the name of Hydra.

Etala Rajender's statements underline growing tensions over land ownership and the treatment of the poor living in these areas, as political leaders continue to voice their concerns.

## MLC Kavitha Calls for Review of Ration Card Distribution Process

She revealed that approximately 1.27 lakh applications were submitted through Meeseva in Nizamabad but only 26,000 applications were processed based on the caste census, leaving a large number of applicants unaddressed.

Kavitha expressed concern that excluding the remaining applicants was unfair and called for greater transparency in the ration card issuance process. She further requested the government to disclose the details of the public administration applications received. Additionally, she suggested revisiting the income limit criteria for ration cards, advocating for a review to ensure the system serves all eligible citizens fairly.

In her address, Kavitha also welcomed the provision of 3,500 houses in her constituency through the Indiramma Indlu scheme but urged the government to settle the pending bills for partially constructed houses from the past. She

If that happens, the situation here may become more pathetic.

#### WHAT IF REVANTH REDDY DOESN'T BECOME CM AGAIN?

This is the major setback for real estate. This is the concern and doubt among all the real estate people. That is why the Future City and new Metro routes are not making an impact on the real estate market. They are saying, "Mr. Revanth Reddy has changed metro routes and plans after coming to power. If he loses power in the next elections, the coming Government may change these plans again, and then we will be losers." Moreover, Mr. Revanth Reddy is CM on behalf of Congress, and the party can change the CM at any time as per their history. All these doubts are circulating in the minds of the people, and they are hesitant to invest in real estate.

Most of the analysts are naming HYDRA as a major factor, but that is not the truth, if we discuss with the people at the ground level. Before HYDRA, common people were used to buying plots or flats by believing builders. But after HYDRA, people are checking all the plans and approvals, and then only they are willing to buy. This is the only change that has come. But the builders who were used to manipulating the rules to get high margins have faced a setback due to HYDRA. That part of the business has come down, mainly because of the HYDRA implementation.

So, the Chief Minister Mr. Revanth Reddy has to build confidence among people that he will come back to power. If that environment is seen, people will invest with confidence; otherwise, the real estate sector cannot regain its pace as before.

He alleged that Revanth Reddy's ill-considered decisions had caused damage to the state, particularly in terms of the systems that Chief Minister KCR had established, including 24-hour electricity, a reliable water supply, law and order, and an environment conducive to investment. According to Vivekananda, Revanth's actions had reversed these achievements, further damaging the state's prospects for future growth.

Vivekananda also criticized Revanth Reddy's comments on the government's handling of investments. He pointed out how Revanth claimed that the government's decisions had caused losses to organizations, even ordering the arrest of a representative who voiced these concerns. The BRS MLA also questioned Revanth's promises related to loan waivers and the implementation of 6 guarantees in just 100 days, calling them false assurances.

Vivekananda concluded by emphasizing that the people of Telangana would not forget Revanth's negative remarks about the state and questioned how the public could trust someone who had undermined the state's progress with such statements.





## Land Grabbing Case **Against YV Subbareddy**

Police Register Case Over Gachibowli Land Dispute Former TTD Chief Faces Legal Action in Land Grab

Hyderabad : A land grabbing case has been registered against former TTD chairman YV Subbareddy at the Gachibowli police station, sparking significant attention. The complaint alleges that Subbareddy attempted to grab two acres and thirty pits of land located in Kondapur Survey No. 87. The accusations also include demolishing boundary walls

and using a JCB machine to encroach on the land.

The police have registered the case under sections 329(3), 324(4), 351(2), and r/w 3(5) of the BNS Act against Subbareddy along with his followers, including Y. Chinnapol Reddy, Y. Swarnalathareddy, Anil Kumar, Nagi Reddy, Kukatapalli Siva, Moin, and others.

The complainant, Narasimha Reddy, claims that Subbareddy encroached upon his land with the assistance of other individuals. Narasimha Reddy further alleged that Subbareddy not only encroached on the property but also altered the nameboard to his advantage. The dispute involves land that Subbareddy allegedly purchased from Anil Reddy, who later accused Subbareddy of illegally seizing the land. Anil Reddy and Narasimha Reddy are reportedly followers of Telangana's Medical and Health Minister Damodar Rajanarasimha.

Both parties have filed complaints, and the police are currently investigating the case based on the mutual accusations. This legal dispute has stirred significant controversy and is currently under scrutiny by local authorities.

## **KTR Criticizes Congress for** Double Standards, Calls It a Lesson

## 62 Kg Ganja Seized in Hyderabad, One Arrested

Hyderabad | Jan 20: An interstate drug peddler was arrested in Hyderabad on Saturday, January 18, with the police seizing 62 kg of ganja worth Rs 15.5 lakh. The arrest was made by the Commissioner's Task Force South East Zone, in coordination with the Chaderghat police, at Nalgonda X Road. The accused, identified as 35-year-old Raju Jat Raju, an ice cream vendor and drug peddler, is originally from Madhya Pradesh and has been operating from Maharashtra.

During interrogation, Raju confessed to peddling ganja for five years, supplying it to a consumer named Purshottam from

Maharashtra. He revealed that he had purchased the ganja from a supplier named Subhash in Odisha. On January 11, Purshottam placed an order for the ganja, which Raju was transporting to Maharashtra when he was apprehended while waiting for a taxi to the Kachiguda railway station.

Raju has been booked under the NDPS Act, and the investigation is ongoing.

In a related incident on Friday, railway police arrested two women, Ishrat Bano and Kanchan, for smuggling ganja at the Secunderabad railway station, seizing ganja worth Rs 4.4 lakh from them.

### Two Die in Accident in Hyderabad's Kanchanbagh

Hyderabad | Jan 20: Two people lost their lives while another person was injured in a tragic accident that took place in Kanchanbagh, Hyderabad, early on Sunday, January 19. The accident occurred near Vikas High School on Kanchanbagh Road when the motorists lost control of their vehicle.

### Madhapur Cannabis, Hash Oil Bust, IT Employees Arrested

## Fraud in Bar Licenses Accused Arrested in Hyderabad

### Hyderabad Restaurant **Under Fire After Woman Finds Snail in Salad**

### Arvind Kejriwal Admits to Unfulfilled Promises Ahead of Delhi Polls

TPN Correspondent | New Delhi Ahead of the February 5 Delhi assembly elections, Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) national convenor Arvind Kejriwal acknowledged his government's failure to fulfil three major promises. Addressing a gathering in Laxmi Bai Nagar on Saturday, Mr. Kejriwal reassured the public of his commitment to completing the projects in the next five years. • Kejriwal admitted falling short on promises to clean the Yamuna, ensure 24-hour drinking water, and upgrade Delhi's roads to European standards.

· He reiterated his focus on completing these projects in two to three years.

• Congress leader Sandeep Dikshit criticized the AAP government for the capital's pollution crisis.

"I am truthful to my promises. I could not fulfil three commitments: cleaning the Yamuna river, providing clean drinking water round the clock, and transforming Delhi's roads to European stan-



dards," Kejriwal admitted. He added that efforts to clean the Yamuna will take two to three years, with ongoing work already showing progress.

On the issue of clean water, Mr. Kejriwal highlighted an initiative launched recently in Rajendra Nagar, stating, "24-hour drinking water supply has begun in one

colony, and this will be expanded across Delhi." He reaffirmed that all three promises would be fulfilled within the next term if re-elected. Congress Criticizes AAP on Pollution and Infrastructure

Congress leader Sandeep Dikshit, contesting from the New Delhi constituency, criticized the AAP government for failing to address

pollution in Delhi and the Yamuna River. At a press conference, he accused the Kejriwal government of neglecting sewage treatment facilities, resulting in the Yamuna becoming the "most polluted stretch" in the world.

"The Kejriwal government boasted in 2023 about cleaning the Yamuna but has made little progress," said Dikshit. He also dismissed the blame placed on stubble burning for Delhi's air pollution, citing vehicle emissions, weak public transport infrastructure, and reduced green cover as the primary causes. Dikshit further claimed that the number of Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) buses had decreased from 5,500 in 2013 to around 3,000, indicating a failure to enhance public transportation in the capital.

With promises and criticism shaping the election discourse, the upcoming polls will serve as a crucial test for the Kejriwal-led AAP government.

Four, Including Two Children, Die in **Ghaziabad House Fire**

The victims were asleep when the fire engulfed their home. The deceased have been identified as Gulbahar (32), her two minor sons, and a relative's son who lived in the same house. Gulbahar's husband, Shahnawaz, managed to escape unhurt. Chief Fire Officer Rahul confirmed that firefighters recovered the charred bodies after extinguishing the blaze. "The fire broke out in the early hours while the family was asleep. Unfortunately, four lives were lost in the incident," he said.

The tragic loss underscores the importance of ensuring electrical safety in residential areas. Local authorities are investigating further to prevent such incidents in the future.

### **Olympic Medallist Manu Bhaker's Grandmother** and Uncle Killed in **Road Accident**

Olympic medallist Manu Bhaker has been struck by a personal tragedy as her maternal grandmother, Savitri Devi, and uncle, Yudhveer Singh, were killed in a road accident in Charkhi Dadri, Haryana, on Sunday, January 19. The accident occurred around 9 am on Mahendragarh Bypass Road when a Brezza car collided with the scooter on which Bhaker's relatives were travelling. Reports indicate that the car driver fled the scene following the accident. Local authorities have launched an investigation into the incident. A relative of the deceased spoke to the media, explaining that the accident took place under foggy weather conditions. "There was fog, they met with an accident. We appeal to the administration to investigate it properly. They were Manu Bhaker's maternal uncle and maternal grandmother," the relative said. Upon receiving the distress call, the police arrived at the scene, took the bodies into custody, and sent them for post-mortem at the civil hospital. ASI Suresh Kumar of the local police station confirmed the details of the accident, stating that the victims died at the spot and the car driver had yet to be found. "We got the information about the accident involving a car and a scooter. Both the persons on the scooter died. We could not find the driver of the car at the spot," Kumar said. The tragic loss comes just two days after Bhaker, a celebrated shooter, was conferred with the prestigious Khel Ratna Award by President Droupadi Murmu. The sudden demise of her family members has cast a shadow over her recent achievement. The authorities are continuing their investigation into the circumstances surrounding the accident, and efforts are underway to locate the driver responsible for the collision.

### **Rahul Gandhi Faces FIR Over Remark on Fighting Indian State** TPN Correspondent | Guwahati

Rahul Gandhi, the Leader of the Opposition, is facing legal trouble following his remarks during the inauguration of the Congress Party's new headquarters on January 15 in Delhi. Gandhi's statement, where he accused the BJP and RSS of capturing institutions and claimed the Congress is "fighting the BJP, the RSS, and the Indian State itself," has led to an FIR being filed against him in Guwahati.

The complaint, lodged by Monjit Chetia at Pan Bazar Police Station, cites sections 152 and 197(1)d of the BNS for "acts endangering the sovereignty, unity, and integrity of India." These charges are cognizable and non-bailable.

In the FIR, the complainant alleged



that Gandhi's remarks crossed the boundaries of permissible free speech and posed a significant risk to public order. "By declaring that his fight is against the 'Indian State itself,' the accused has consciously incited subversive activities and rebellion among the populace. This is an attempt to delegitimize the authority of the State and to portray it as a hostile force," Chetia stated.

He further attributed Gandhi's comments to frustration over repeated electoral failures, claiming the Opposition leader is using his platform irresponsibly. "Instead of maintaining public confidence in democratic institutions, he has chosen to provoke rebellion, endangering India's unity and sovereignty," Chetia added.

### **Budget FY26: Govt could** cut customs duty on raw materials to boost manufacturing

**T**n a bid to boost local I manufacturing, the government is considering reducing customs duties on raw materials used in industries such as medical equipment, electronics, and footwear in the upcoming Union Budget for FY26. Tax experts suggest that this move could help streamline the sector and reduce classification disputes.

Deloitte India's Partner for Indirect Tax, Harpreet Singh, shared that key demands for the 2025-26 Budget, to be presented in Parliament on February 1, would focus on simplifying customs duties, rationalizing the rate structure, and managing disputes. Singh believes the government will likely reduce customs duties on raw materials in sectors like healthcare, electronics, home appliances, and pharmaceuticals, which have been prioritized for boosting local manufacturing under the phased manufacturing plan.

The rationalization of customs duties, which is expected to be a significant feature of the FY26 Budget,



could lead to a reduction in raw material costs for sectors such as medical equipment, white goods, electronics, footwear, and toys. Singh noted that a comprehensive review of the customs duty rate structure was announced in the 2024-25 Budget to help simplify the regime, reduce duty inversion, and minimize disputes in the future.

**T**ndia is set to permit the export of 1 million metric tons Lof sugar during the current season, according to government and industry sources. This move aims to help sugar mills export surplus stocks from the world's second-largest producer of sugar while stabilizing local prices.

The Indian government is expected to soon issue an official order allowing the export of the 1 million tons of sugar. This decision, which had been speculated in recent weeks, could add downward pressure to global sugar prices, as India's surplus will add to global supply. Sources, who wished to remain anonymous, revealed the upcoming announcement but were not authorized to speak to the media.

The move comes as a surprise to many traders, given that India's sugar production is expected to fall short of consumption for the first time in eight years. Maharashtra, Karnataka, and Uttar Pradesh account for over 80% of the country's total sugar production. However, lower cane yields in these states have led to revised output estimates for the 2024-25 season.

Sugar production in India is projected to drop to approximately 27 million tons from 32 million tons last year, falling short of the country's annual consumption of over 29 million tons. Despite the reduced production estimates, India remains one of the largest sugar exporters globally, with its export markets including Indonesia, Bangladesh, and the UAE. India was the second-largest sugar exporter from 2018 to 2022, averaging 6.8 million tons annually.

Deepak Ballani, Director General of the Indian Sugar and Bio-energy Manufacturers Association, commented that the limited export of 1 million tons is good news for the sugar industry, as next year's production is expected to be stronger. This move will likely offer some relief to sugar mills and ensure a more balanced supply chain, despite the shortfall in domestic production.

Since then, it has remained a divisive dish, adored by some and reviled by others.

The restaurant is also running a poll to determine if pineapple should become a permanent fixture on their monthly special menu, with pineapple currently leading at 62%.

Interestingly, Lupa's pricing is not the highest for pineapple-based products. Last year, a red-hued pineapple variant in California was priced at nearly Rs 34,280, showing just how far some are willing to go for the tropical fruit.

While some traditional pizza makers reject pineapple, others, like Naples' Gino Sorbillo, are embracing it, aiming to combat food prejudice.


