# Dy CM Pawan Kalyan Instructs Formation of New Cluster **Division and Grade Allocation Committee for Villages**

**TPN Correspondent** Amaravati, Jan 21

Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan has directed officials from the Panchayat Raj department to ensure continuous Panchayat services for rural communities, addressing the issue of staff shortages in rural areas.

In a recent meeting, Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan emphasized the need for revisions in the current cluster policy for village Panchayats under the Panchayat Raj department. He instructed officials to introduce new guidelines that factor in both income and population for the division of cluster grades. Previously, cluster grades were allocated based solely on the income of Panchayats, but now



the population density will also play a significant role in the new policy. Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan acknowledged that some Panchayats with high income but low pop-

ulations and others with low income but high populations posed challenges in the previous grading system. He directed officials to adjust the cluster grades based on these

circumstances to ensure fairness. Furthermore, he stressed the importance of coordination between Gram Panchayat and Secretariat staff to ensure the effective implethe maintenance of basic services such as drinking water supply, street lights, internal roads, and sanitation.

To facilitate these changes, the Deputy CM announced the formation of a new committee to study the division of new clusters and allocation of grades. The committee will consist of four senior officials from the Panchayat Raj department and will review reports from district collectors, taking into account both income and population statistics. The committee will then submit its recommendations to the government, paving the way for the distribution of Panchayat and Secretariat staff according to the new cluster grades.

## Katasani Ramireddy Key Follower Arrested by Banaganapalle Police

Tensions Escalated in Banaganapalle After the Arrested Abdul Faiz







Tensions escalated in Banaganapalle after the police arrested Abdul Faiz, a close aide of former YSRCP MLA Katasani Ramireddy, and his son Abdul Ubed. The Banaganapalle police have registered a case against four individuals, including Abdul Faiz's brother Abdul Khair and Ismail (Ammaba), under SC, ST and other sec-

The situation intensified when former MLA Katasani Ramireddy arrived at the police station, accompanied by family members of Abdul Faiz, along with YSRCP party leaders and activ-

ists. Speaking to the media, Ramireddy questioned the justification behind the case filed against Abdul Faiz and his family. "Five days ago, Abdul Faiz entered Minister BC Janardhan Reddy's compound with a drone camera during the wedding of his son Abdul Ubed. How can a case under SC, ST 307 be filed for creating a rift?" Ramireddy asked.

He further urged that action be taken against Minister BC Janardhan Reddy, calling for his removal from the ministerial post by Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu and Pawan Kalyan.

According to Don DSP Srinivasulu, the incident occurred when a drone camera was flying near Minister BC Janardhan Reddy's residence during the wedding celebrations of Abdul Faiz's son. Based on Minister Reddy's complaint, a case was filed under three sections, and Abdul Faiz was arrested. The police announced

that the remaining three individuals involved in the case will also be arrested soon.

Abdul Faiz's wife, Mubina Shamim, Vice President of Banaganapalle Mandal Parishad, expressed her anger, accusing Minister BC Janardhan Reddy of fueling hatred against the Muslim minorities in the area. She claimed that the minister was unaware of the cultural practices followed by Muslim families during weddings and had sent his supporters to attack her family

Abdul Faiz's son, Abdul Ubed, also voiced his concerns, stating that the case filed against his family was unjust, especially given that it was only three days after his marriage.

The issue has sparked widespread political and community discussions, with both local leaders and the public calling for a fair investigation into the matter.

## **YS Sharmila Challenges Amit Shah to Investigate YSRCP's Past Five-Year Rule**

Accusing YSRCP chief Jagan Mohan Reddy of being a mere "puppet" and "rubber stamp" for the BJP, Sharmila said, "For five years, Jagan was your adopted son, an agent who plundered the state's natural resources for 'Modani'." She alleged that the BJP used the YSRCP as a tool for looting the state's wealth, only to now shed "crocodile tears" over the destruction caused.

Sharmila further criticized the BJP for not fulfilling promises related to the state's division, accusing the party of fraud and ma-

nipulation. She demanded immediate action, saying, "If you have the courage, conduct an investigation into the last five years of YSRCP rule by central investigation agencies."

Sharmila's comments have intensified the ongoing political tensions, highlighting the sharp divide between the Congress party and the BJP over governance issues in Andhra Pradesh.

### If You Remove Our Shops, We Will Cut **Ourselves With Blades - Protestor** Tension in Gudivada Over Roadside **Encroachment Removal**

Tensions flared in Gudivada as municipal town planning officials and police moved to remove roadside encroachments near the new municipal office, particularly along the road leading from the main road to the Gudivada NTR Stadium. The operation targeted businesses along the sides of the road, near the veterinary hospital, but met with fierce resistance from local traders.

The conflict began when municipal sanitation staff began loading goods from the traders' stalls onto tractors for removal. This sparked protests from several businessmen, with some threatening to harm themselves. "If you remove our shops, we will cut ourselves with blades," one protestor said. Others vowed to sit in the drainage system and go on a hunger strike, while some traders threatened to set their shops on fire by pouring petrol on them.

The situation escalated as the eviction continued. Several traders were



cleared from one side of the road, but tensions arose when police and revenue officials clashed over why traders on the opposite side had not been removed yet.

Despite the tension, some female traders vacated the area, only to return later and place their carts back in the same spot, under the watch of both police and municipal officials. The authorities stood by as these traders reoccupied the space, further intensifying the stand-off.

The situation remains unresolved, with traders voicing strong opposition to the encroachment removal, while municipal authorities continue to press for enforcement.





# Diarrhea Under Control in Billalavalasa Village

### Medical camp organized to ensure health and safety of villagers

She stated that the capital is grappling with severe infrastructural issues, with broken roads, overflowing sewers, and heaps of garbage becoming common sights.

Maliwal highlighted the plight of residents in areas like Dwarka and Bhalswa, emphasizing that colonies and slums in these regions are receiving contaminated tap water. "The water is so polluted that one may fall sick even by touching it," she said. According to her, while water is officially provided for free, residents are forced to spend money daily to purchase clean drinking water from external sourc-

The remarks have sparked discussions about Delhi's civic administration, raising questions about governance and priorities in the capital city.

## Delhi Airport To Halt Operations For 145 Minutes Daily Until Republic Day

In preparation for Republic Day celebrations, Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi will temporarily close its runway for 145 minutes every day until January 26. # Sanjay Roy Sentenced to Life Imprisonment in RG Kar Rape and Murder Case

Sanjay Roy, convicted in the RG Kar rape and murder case involving a 31-year-old postgraduate trainee doctor, has been sentenced to life imprisonment by the Sealdah CBI Court in Kolkata. Roy was found guilty of the crime, which took place on the night of August 8-9, 2024, at the RG Kar Medical College and Hospital.

The court imposed a fine of ₹50,000 on Roy, but denied him the death penalty, stating that the crime did not qualify as "rarest of rare." The victim's family will be compensated with ₹17 lakh by the West Bengal government, as directed by the court.

The conviction was based on strong forensic evidence, including CCTV footage and phone signals. Sanjay Roy's injuries were consistent with those found on the victim's fingernails, and DNA samples from hair at the crime scene matched Roy's DNA.

Roy, a civic volunteer with the Kolkata Police, was arrested in August 2024. Despite the evidence, he continued to claim that he was being falsely implicated and attributed his actions to instructions from "IPS officers."



## "If Case Stayed With Us..." Mamata Banerjee on RG Kar Case Verdict

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee expressed dissatisfaction with the life imprisonment verdict in the RG Kar rape and murder case. Banerjee claimed that had the case remained under Kolkata Police, the convict would have faced the death penalty, highlighting her government's stance on ensuring justice in such cases. The verdict followed a CBI probe after the Supreme Court intervened, with the prosecution failing to prove the 'rarest of the rare' criteria for capital punishment. The court also awarded Rs 17 lakh financial aid to the victim's parents, who rejected it, insisting on justice.



## **Approves Uniform Civil Code Manual**

The Pushkar Singh Dhami-led Uttarakhand Cabinet approved the manual for the Uniform Civil Code (UCC) during a meeting held at the state secretariat on Monday. The dates for its implementation will be announced soon.

The manual was approved after the partial amendment of the rules, which were recently prepared for the UCC's implementation. The amended rules were thoroughly examined by the Law Department and discussed at the meeting chaired by Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami.

Post-meeting, CM Dhami reaffirmed the government's commitment to fulfilling its 2022 electoral promise of implementing the UCC. He said, "We promised the people of Uttarakhand during the 2022 elections that UCC will be implemented as soon as our government is formed. We brought it, the draft committee drafted it, and it was passed. The President approved it, making it an Act. The training process is almost complete."

Dhami also highlighted the significance of Uttarakhand becoming the first state in India to implement the UCC, stressing that careful preparation is crucial as they are setting a precedent. "The dates will be announced soon, and we have thoroughly examined it," he added. The UCC aims to create a unified legal framework across all religious communities in areas such as marriage, divorce, inheritance, adoption, and maintenance. While India already has a uniform criminal code, a similar civil law framework does not yet exist. The law excludes tribal communities and bans practices such as 'halala', 'iddat', and 'talag', which are part of the Muslim Personal Law.

In a shocking and sensational case, a court in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, recently sentenced Greeshma, a 24-year-old woman from Tamil Nadu, to death for the murder of her boyfriend, Sharon Raj. The verdict has sent shockwaves across the country, highlighting the extreme measures taken in a crime driven by personal motives.

### The Story Behind the Murder

Greeshma and Raj, both in their early twenties, had been in a romantic relationship for some time. However, the situation took a drastic turn in 2022 when Greeshma got engaged to another man, an army personnel, while still involved with Raj. Despite the engagement, Greeshma continued her love affair with Raj, leading to tension as the wedding date approached.

Raj, hoping to continue their relationship, became insistent when Greeshma attempted to distance herself from him. # "Want To See Child": Supreme Court on **Custody Battle of Atul Subhash's Son**

The Supreme Court on Monday evening saw the four-year-old son of Atul Subhash, a Bengaluru techie who tragically died by suicide in December, being produced for the ongoing custody battle. The boy's estranged mother, Nikita Singhania, appeared in court after a plea was filed by Anju Devi, Subhash's mother, seeking custody of her grandson.

As the hearing commenced, Justice BV Nagarathna and Jus-

ly, stating, "This is a habeas corpus (petition)... we want to see the child." The petitioners had request-

tice SC Sharma insisted on seeing the child directed a week's time to file a more detailed affidavit, but the court dismissed the request, emphasizing the child must be presented.

Earlier this month, Singhania's lawyer had informed the court that the boy was a student at a boarding school in Faridabad, Haryana, and would be withdrawn to accompany her to Bengaluru.

In addition to Singhania's ongoing custody issues, she and her family face charges of abetting Subhash's suicide. Atul Subhash's father, Pawan Kumar, along with Anju Devi, has publicly sought custody of the boy, claiming that Singhania has failed to disclose his whereabouts. The court directed the authorities of Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, and Haryana to clarify the situation, as Singhania's uncle later denied knowing the child's location.

Subhash, in his final note, accused his wife and her family of harass-

ing him and making false accusations. His death has sparked discussions on the misuse of legal provisions meant to protect women from cruelty.

During the 2020 presidential campaign, Joe Biden had dismissed the laptop's revelations as a "Russian plan," citing endorsements from intelligence officials. The controversy intensified when further investigations verified the laptop's authenticity, leaving Trump's allies critical of the intelligence community's role in shaping public opinion before the elec-

## **Pope Francis Criticizes Trump's Immigration Plan** as a 'Disgrace'

## China Executes Man Behind Zhuhai Car Rampage, Killing 35

Fan, 62, drove an SUV into crowds outside a sports complex, with a court later describing his motives as "extremely vile" and the crime's nature as "egregious." After being detained at the scene with self-inflicted knife


eventually pleading guilty in front was put to death for a mass stabbing of victims' families and the public at a vocational school in Wuxi that during his trial.

### Rupee likely to rebound strongly once market stabilizes: SBI Report

The Indian rupee is expected to recover strongly once current market uncertainties subside, according to a recent report by the State Bank of India (SBI). While the Dollar Index (DXY) might still have some upward momentum, SBI draws parallels to the 2016-2017 period, when the rupee experienced a significant rebound after a phase of volatility.

The report suggests that although the Dollar Index may continue to rise due to factors like a reversal of global financial flows towards the United States, the situation is expected to stabilize. It highlights that the dominance of "Big Tech" companies and pro-economic growth policies, such as former U.S. President Donald Trump's "Make America Great Again" rhetoric, are contributing to the dollar's strength.

However, this rise in the DXY is creating chal-



lenges for emerging market (EM) currencies, including the rupee. The report notes that the Euro-Dollar parity is being factored into global bank calculations, which could further weaken EM currencies. Additionally, the volatility of US benchmark yields and potential inflationary pressures, such as tariffs on imports, are further affecting global currencies.

Domestically, SBI points out that India's currency in circulation (CIC) has increased by Rs 78,000 crore this fiscal year, reaching approximately 11% of the country's GDP. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has been actively intervening in the forex market, with net forex sales crossing Rs 1.7 lakh crore as of November 2024. This intervention is part of efforts to stabilize the depreciating rupee, and the figure is believed to have grown further.

While the rupee has faced significant challenges from global economic factors, SBI believes the worst may be over. A recovery in the rupee's value is expected once global uncertainties settle, providing a hopeful outlook for India's currency in the near future.





Others suggested that the cheaper alternatives were likely counterfeit versions. In response, the company took to social media, tweeting, "While the world debates the chicken or the egg, we're focused on what we do best – creating originals worth imitating."

Amidst the controversy, Mokobara launched a new product line, the Moko x Naruto Series, offering a 10% discount with the promo code "WHITELABEL" to address the allegations. The company invited its customers to use the code, writing, "To our Moko fam, this one's for you. Use code WHITELABEL to get 10 percent off on originality!" However, the response was met with mixed reactions on X (formerly Twitter), with some appreciating the playful approach, while others criticized the company for not addressing the issue directly.

Some users defended the brand, noting that many top companies, including well-established ones, source products from China or other countries. A user pointed out that "manufacturing low-tech stuff in China carries the risk of copycats." Others, however, felt that the brand's response was a marketing stunt rather than a proper clarification.

Mokobara, founded in 2019 by former Urban Ladder executives Sangeet Agrawal and Navin Parwal, specializes in mid-premium to premium travel accessories, including laptop bags and suitcases. The company competes with established luggage brands like American Tourister, VIP, and Samsonite. Mokobara secured Rs 100 crore in Series B funding in February 2024, indicating significant growth in the direct-to-consumer luggage market.

Last year, she entered the tournament in strong form but was forced to retire from her fourth-round match against Linda Noskova due to a back injury. After undergoing foot surgery following a challenging season, this marks Svitolina's first tournament back on the WTA tour.




