CM Strengthens AP's Global Presence at Davos With Investment Invitations

On the second day of the World Economic Forum (WEF) conference in Davos, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu intensified efforts to position Andhra Pradesh as a premier investment destination. Hosting a bustling AP Pavilion at the WEF, Chandrababu engaged with global business tycoons, exploring collaboration opportunities to propel the state's growth.

Key Meetings and Proposals

1. Maersk CEO Vincent Clerk Chandrababu highlighted Andhra

Visakhapatnam and a semiconductor unit in Tirupati. Assuring full support, he encouraged LG Chem to explore Andhra Pradesh as a key destination for manufacturing and innovation.

4. Carlsberg Group CEO Jacob Arup Anderson

Chandrababu proposed that Carlsberg Group establish an integrated brewery and bottling unit in Andhra Pradesh. He suggested locations such as Visakhapatnam, Krishnapatnam, and Sri City, while advocating partnerships with local farmers to source high-quality produce like barley, maize, and rice for Carlsberg's operations.

Collector Issues Notices to DRO Malola for Playing **Rummy During Serious Meeting TPN Correspondent**

Anantapur, Jan 22

In a shocking incident, District Revenue Officer (DRO) Malola was caught playing online rummy during an important meeting at the Anantapur District Collectorate, chaired by Rajiv Ranjan Mishra, Chairman of the Single-Member Commission on SC Classification. The incident, which occurred at the Revenue Bhavan, has sparked outrage across Andhra Pradesh.

District Collector Vinod Kumar responded swiftly, ordering an investigation into the DRO's inappropriate behavior. Notices were issued to Malola, demanding an explanation for his actions during the meeting. The Collector directed the Joint Collector to conduct a thorough inquiry, stating that appropriate action would be taken based on the findings of the report.

The meeting, attended by senior officials including Collectors Vinod Kumar and Chetan, SP Jagadish, and Assistant Collector Vinootna, was focused on the critical issue of SC classification. However, while the discussion progressed, DRO Malola was seen engrossed in playing rummy on his smartphone, disregarding the seriousness of the proceedings.

Eyewitnesses reported that despite the presence of higher officials and numerous associations submitting petitions on the SC classification issue, the DRO appeared indifferent, immersed in his game. This behavior has drawn severe criticism from the public and government employees, who expressed anger over the irresponsibility shown by a senior official in such a crucial meeting. Collectorate staff alleged that DRO Malola has a history of indulging in online poker during office hours. Citizens have demanded strict disciplinary action against the DRO, emphasizing the need for accountability and professionalism in government offices.

Roads and Development Reviewed by Minister Anitha At Vizianagaram

"Govt Takes Steps to Curb Drug Addiction and Ensure Liquor Quality"

TPN Correspondent Visakhapatnam, Jan 22

Minister Kollu Ravindra has accused the previous YSRCP government of drastically increasing liquor prices, leading to widespread addiction to low-cost substances like marijuana among the youth. He stated that the coalition government, led by Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, is taking decisive measures to address these issues by ensuring quality control in liquor sales and implementing strict regulations.

During an inspection of the Jerry Pothulapalem depot of Andhra Pradesh Beverages Corporation on Tuesday, Minister Ravindra reviewed records and interacted with depot workers to understand their challenges. He highlighted the shortcomings of the previous government, which lacked a proper scanning system to



track liquor sales, allowing alcohol from neighboring states to enter the market unchecked. The minister pointed out that under the YSRCP government, drastic hikes in liquor prices made alcohol unaffordable for many, pushing youth towards marijuana. In contrast, the coalition government has introduced a six-step testing process for liquor to ensure quality and improve public health. He added that the government's efforts aim to pro-

vide affordable and safe liquor while preventing adulteration and illegal sales.

Minister Ravindra also announced the implementation of a new program, "Navodaya," starting January 29, which focuses on controlling adulterated alcohol. Key features include:

Allocation of 10% of liquor shops to Kallu Geetha workers with a 50% concession in license fees.

Strict action against belt shops, including filing cases and seizing operations.

Efforts to address insufficient margins for wine shop owners.

The minister assured that the coalition government is committed to addressing the issues caused by the previous administration's policies and ensuring a safer and healthier environment for the youth of Andhra Pradesh.

Janasena Leader Politically and Morally Isolated

Mr. Seeram Santosh, a secondary-level leader in Janasena working in Guduru Mandal of Pedana constituency, is now hospitalized after attempting suicide by consuming pesticide. His condition remains critical. The incident, which highlights a rift within the alliance, occurred in the presence of Pedana Constituency MLA Mr. Kagita Krishna Prasad and Guduru TDP President Mr. Potina Swamy Naidu. Shockingly, both were in the same car and simply left the scene after Santosh's drastic step.

The issue arose from ₹1 lakh in Panchayat funds allocated for Kankatava village, the native place of Santosh. The funds, ordered by Mr. Pawan Kalyan during his tenure as Panchayat Raj Minister, were intended for local development. Santosh proposed gathering villagers to decide on utilizing the funds. However, Swamy Naidu rejected the idea, asserting that he alone would decide on the fund's utilization. With the help of officials, Swamy Naidu reportedly blocked Santosh's plans and falsely claimed the funds had not been released.

When Santosh discovered the funds had been disbursed and were under Swamy Naidu's control, he questioned the TDP leadership and filed complaints with the MLA and Janasena leaders. Instead of addressing the issue, Swamy Naidu allegedly resorted to abusive language, humili-

ating Santosh and other Janasena workers. Audio evidence of the abuse was submitted, but no action was taken. To Santosh's further dismay, Swamy Naidu was later promoted to Water Association President with the MLA's backing. This neglect and disregard for Janasena cadre's grievances pushed Santosh to confront the MLA on the road. In frustration and despair, he consumed pesticide in front of the MLA, who left the scene without intervening.

Santosh's father has now questioned both the TDP and Janasena leadership: "My son worked tirelessly for the alliance despite our poor financial situation. Now, who will answer for his plight—TDP or Janasena leaders?"

This incident highlights the lack of coordination and monitoring within the TDP-Janasena alliance, leading to growing discontent among Janasena cadres, particularly those from modest financial backgrounds who worked hard to secure the alliance's victory.

Criticism Over Incomplete Works at Ambedkar Statue Site in Vijayawada

Former Minister Nagarjuna and Vice RCP cadres have raised strong objections to the current state of the Ambedkar statue, constructed by former Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy. The 125-foot statue, dedicated to Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, has been a point of contention since its installation over a year ago.

Nagarjuna and other leaders criticized the new government for neglecting the statue site after the change of power, highlighting that several promised developments were either delayed or left incomplete. They pointed out that the names were removed from the statue, the night lights were taken down, and it is now being rented out to businesses instead of being maintained as a significant cultural site.

The leaders also questioned why the statue was not installed in Amaravati over the five years of the previous government. They further highlighted the lack of progress on the promised federal and convention centers, with basic facilities like air conditioners, canteens, and boundary walls still missing. Salaries for employees working at the site have reportedly not been paid.

In their statement, the leaders expressed concerns about the government's apparent disregard for Dr.



Ambedkar's legacy, calling it an attempt to undermine his ideology. They demanded the completion of the remaining works and the restoration of the statue's significance as a historical and cultural landmark. Karnataka's Social Welfare Minister's team had previously praised the statue's construction under the leadership of the former CM. Nagarjuna and the coalition leaders have now called for a detailed investigation into the halted works and any irregularities in the project. They emphasized that the Ambedkar statue must be preserved and developed properly for future generations.

Jaggayyapet Police Seize 218 kg of Cannabis at Chillakallu Toll Plaza, Four Arrested

In a significant drug bust, Jaggayyapet Police seized 218 kg of cannabis worth approximately ₹30 lakhs at the Chillakallu Toll Plaza. The operation was conducted as part of the state government's ongoing efforts to eradicate cannabis trafficking and make Andhra Pradesh a cannabis-free state.

Delhi Election 2025 and the Battle for Kalkaji

The battle for Kalkaji in the upcoming Delhi Assembly elections is shaping up to be a high-stakes contest with Delhi CM Atishi of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) facing fierce competition from BJP's Ramesh Bidhuri and Congress' Alka Lamba, who is aiming for a revival of the grand-old party in the National Capital.

- AAP's Atishi faces stiff competition from BJP's Ramesh Bidhuri and Congress' Alka Lamba in Kalkaji.

Atishi, who has been representing Kalkaji for the AAP, is seeking re-election and has already embarked on a series of rallies and roadshows to galvanize voter support. A day before filing her nomination, Atishi held a major roadshow in Giri Nagar to connect with residents and garner backing for the AAP's third-term aspirations. Under AAP's tenure, Kalkaji has seen initiatives like Mohalla Clinics, MCD school upgrades, and welfare programs. However, with anti-incumbency sentiment at an all-time high and allegations of scams and flip-flopping from Arvind Kejriwal, the party's fortunes might be at risk.

BJP's Ramesh Bidhuri, known for his criticism of AAP's governance, has tailored his campaign around addressing local issues such as road connectivity, water shortages, the race is the Nationalist Congress Party



and sewage inefficiencies. His promise of implementing similar freebie schemes like AAP's, such as the Atal Canteen offering food for just ₹5, is seen as a bid to attract voters seeking change.

Meanwhile, Congress' Alka Lamba is focusing on women empowerment, critiquing AAP's Mukhya Mantri Mahila Samman Yojana and pledging to provide ₹2,500 to women under the Pyari Didi Scheme. Lamba's campaign calls out AAP for not fulfilling promises made to women over the last decade. During her roadshow in Kalkaji, she posed a pointed question to voters: "If they wanted to give ₹2,100 to you every month, why didn't they do it until now when they have been in power for 10 years?"

An additional factor adding uncertainty to

(NCP) entering the fray, with the party fielding a candidate in Kalkaji. While the NCP has had limited success in Delhi elections, it may disrupt the vote share, potentially affecting the outcome for one of the three major contenders.

The Delhi Assembly elections are set to take place on February 5, 2025, with the results to be announced on February 8, 2025. This election will be closely watched, as AAP seeks to secure a third consecutive term in office, while the BJP hopes to leverage its 2019 Lok Sabha sweep to shift the mandate. Congress, on the other hand, will attempt to make a comeback after being ousted in 2013. With the vote just weeks away, Kalkaji has become a key battleground in the Delhi elections as the three parties fight for supremacy in the constituency.

AAP vs BJP Over Arvind Kejriwal's 'Raavan Came As Golden Deer' Remark

Kejriwal is obsessed with gold even after living in Sheeshmahal," said Sachdeva, referring to alleged irregularities in the renovation of the Chief Minister's residence during Kejriwal's tenure.

The BJP also announced that its leaders would fast in protest, asserting their commitment to safeguarding Hindu traditions. "Lord Ram will do justice," added Sachdeva. Responding to the criticism, AAP leader and former Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia accused the BJP of stooping low by defending Raavan. "Their politics has fallen to the extent of backing Raavan. They may prove more dangerous than Raavan for the poor and workers if they gain power," Sisodia posted on X.

Kejriwal, addressing reporters, mocked BJP's protests, stating, "BJP loves Raavan so much they're camping outside my house. They have demonic tendencies. I warn the poor in Delhi—if these people come to power, they will devour you like demons."

The exchange underscores the heightened political tension in Delhi as the Assembly elections approach, with both parties leveraging faith and mythology to sway voters.

981 Candidates File Nomination For Upcoming Delhi Polls

Ahead of the Delhi Assembly elections in February 2025, a total of 981 candidates filed 1,521 nomination papers, with scrutiny scheduled to take place today. The final date for the withdrawal of nominations is January 20. The Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of Delhi revealed that a significant number of nominations were filed on January 17, the last day for filing. The data shared by the CEO's office highlights the district-wise distribution of nominations. The North district registered the highest number, with 183 nominations from 108 candidates, followed by

South West district, where 153 nominations were filed by 108 contestants.

- 981 candidates filed 1,521 nominations for Delhi Assembly elections.
- North district leads with 183 nominations, followed by South West district with 153 nominations.
- 180 cases of alleged violation of the Model Code of Conduct registered by Delhi Police.

Other districts such as West, Central, New Delhi, North West, and South East also reported substantial nominations. West district saw 170 nominations from 104 candidates, while Central district recorded 154 nominations from 99 candidates. New Delhi district had 135 nominations from 85 candidates, North West district saw 139 nominations from 90 candidates, and South East district recorded 140 nominations from 93 candidates.

Meanwhile, in the lead-up to the elections, Delhi Police registered 180 cases of alleged Model Code of Conduct violations from January 7 to January 14. A total of 7,454 individuals were arrested for various offences, including violations under the Excise Act, as preventive measures to maintain law and order. Delhi will go to the polls on February 5, with results expected on February 8.









Kejriwal's Rare Praise For Sheila Dikshit

14 Naxalites Killed in Chhattisgarh Encounter

HM Amit Shah Says 'Naxalism Breathing Its Last'

In a significant blow to Naxalism, 14 Naxalites, including one carrying a ₹1 crore bounty, were neutralized by Chhattisgarh Police near the Chhattisgarh-Odisha border on Monday. Donald Trump Signs Executive Orders on Day One

Birthright Citizenship, WHO Exit, and more..

Donald Trump, on his first day as the 47th President of the United States, signed a series of executive orders aimed at reversing Biden-era mandates and reinstating his "America First" agenda. The sweeping orders addressed issues ranging from immigration to energy policy and global alliances.

In total, Trump signed over 200 executive actions, including memoranda and proclamations, marking a decisive start to his second presidential term. These actions included: Pardons for Capitol Rioters: Trump pardoned around 1,500 individuals involved in the January 6 Capitol riot, stating his commitment to justice for what he called "political persecutions."

Immigration Reform: Orders declared illegal immigration at the U.S.-Mexico border a national emergency and targeted automatic birthright citizenship for children of undocumented immigrants. He also suspended the U.S. refugee resettlement program for four months.

WHO Exit: Trump fulfilled a campaign promise to withdraw the U.S. from the World Health Organization (WHO), citing its alleged failures during the COVID-19 pandemic and perceived bias toward China.

Paris Climate Agreement Withdrawal: The President signed an order formally withdrawing the U.S. from the Paris Climate Agreement, prioritizing domestic interests over global climate goals.

Energy Policy: Declaring a national energy emergency, Trump announced plans to fill strategic oil reserves and ramp up energy exports, calling oil the "liquid gold" vital to U.S. prosperity.

Federal Hiring Freeze: Trump froze government hiring and mandated federal employees to return to full-time in-person work, rolling back remote working arrangements from the pandemic era.



Economic Measures: Orders were issued to cut regulations, lower housing costs, and re-

peal restrictions on Arctic oil drilling. Weaponization of Law Enforcement: Trump directed investigations into alleged misconduct by federal agencies during the Biden administration.

Empowering the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE): Trump established the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE), led by Elon Musk, to recommend significant cuts to government programs and spending to streamline federal operations.

Rolling Back Transgender Protections: An order was signed declaring that the feder-

al government will officially recognize only two biological sexes—male and female. This move reverses protections extended to transgender individuals under previous administrations.

Additional Orders: Other notable actions included renaming the Gulf of Mexico to the "Gulf of America," reinstating Mount Denali's former name "Mount McKinley," and rolling back protections for transgender individuals.

President Trump emphasized the importance of these actions in his inaugural speech, saying, "We will be a rich nation again, and it is that liquid gold under our feet that will help to do it."

Putin Calls Xi, Vows To Strengthen Ties After Trump Inauguration

Russian President Vladimir Putin and Chinese President Xi Jinping held a video meeting on Tuesday, emphasizing their commitment to strengthening the strategic partnership between their nations. The call came just hours after Donald Trump was inaugurated as the 47th President of the United States.

Addressing Xi as his "dear friend," Putin expressed a desire to chart "new plans for the development of the Russian-Chinese comprehensive partnership and strategic cooperation." The Kremlin released visuals of the meeting, showcasing Putin waving at Xi during the exchange.

Putin highlighted the alignment of Moscow and Beijing's national interests and views on global power relations. "Our ties are self-sufficient and independent of domestic political factors or the current global situation," he noted. The video call reflects a growing bond between Russia and China, both of which face increasing pressure from the West. Russia is engaged in a conflict with NATO-backed Ukrainian forces, while China contends with US measures aimed at countering its military and economic influence. The two leaders have framed the West as decadent and in decline, contrasting it with their nations' shared pushback against historical grievances, including the Soviet collapse and European colonial dominance over China. As the United States identifies China as its top competitor and Russia as its primary nation-state threat, the relationship between Moscow and Beijing appears to deepen, rooted in mutual geopolitical interests.



UK plans "rapid" inquiry into grooming gangs after Starmer-Musk row

The UK government has announced a "rapid" national review of the sexual exploitation of children by grooming gangs, following a heated exchange between US tech billionaire Elon Musk and Prime Minister Keir Starmer earlier this month. The controversy centers around sex offenses that occurred over decades, committed by men of predominantly South Asian origin in several northern English towns. The government's move comes amid heightened public concern over the issue. Interior Minister Yvette Cooper revealed that she had ordered a threemonth "rapid audit" to assess the scale and nature of gang-based exploitation across the country. The review will also consider the "cultural and societal drivers" of child sex abuse, alongside a detailed examination of ethnicity data and the demographics of the gangs and their victims. Cooper emphasized that several local inquiries, similar to those conducted in the past, would be initiated to explore specific cases of abuse. She dismissed the opposition's call for a new national inquiry, arguing that local reviews provide more detailed and relevant insights that can lead to effective change.

India Hails Neutral Expert's Stand on Indus Water Treaty

66 Killed in Fire at Turkey Ski Resort, Some Jumped to Safety

A devastating fire at the Grand Kartal hotel in Kartalkaya ski resort, Turkey, claimed 66 lives and left 51 injured early Tuesday morning. Witnesses reported guests desperately attempting to escape by using ropes, bedsheets, and, tragically, jumping from windows.

The fire broke out at 3:27 am (0027 GMT) in the 12-storey hotel, believed to have start-

ed in the restaurant area. Interior Minister Ali Yerlikaya confirmed the number of casualties and described the incident as a "great pain" for the nation.

President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan expressed deep sorrow over the tragedy, cutting short his address at the AKP party congress. He assured the public of a thorough investigation, stating, "All necessary steps will be taken to uncover the cause and hold those responsible accountable." Television footage depicted thick smoke billowing from the hotel with snowcapped mountains in the background. The wooden-clad structure, partially perched against a cliff, posed challenges for firefighters.

A survivor criticized the hotel's safety standards, alleging the absence of alarms and functional fire stairs. However, Tourism Minister Nuri Ersoy claimed the hotel had two fire escapes.

Extremely Critical Fire Risk as Winds Batter Los Angeles

Southern California faced an "extremely critical" fire risk on Monday as hurricane-force winds swept through the region, raising fears of fresh devastation in an area already reeling from deadly wildfires that have claimed at least 27 lives since January 7.

The National Weather Service (NWS) warned of winds gusting up to 88 miles (142 kilometers) per hour, which, combined with dry conditions, could reignite or fuel new fires. Ariel Cohen of the NWS described the situation as "particularly dangerous," emphasizing the potential for explosive fire growth.

confidence in the city's readiness, saying, "We will be very prepared for the worst-case scenario, though we hope it doesn't come to that."

The disaster has also sparked political debates, with newly sworn-in President Donald Trump taking aim at California's Democratic leadership over their handling of the crisis. Trump criticized the state's response, calling it inadequate, and pledged federal support during his planned visit to the fire-affected areas later this week. Governor Gavin Newsom responded by urging collaboration and mutual respect, emphasizing the need for partnership to address the scale of devastation effectively.




