


IS JAGAN STILLA NIGHTMARE TO THE INVESTORS?

Investors are still fearing Jaganmohan Reddy.

They have doubts about the Alliance **Government's** performance.

It's a really surprising outcome. No agreements, no proposals—this is not the history of Mr. Naidu and not his style either. Even with proposals, he used to portray a rosy picture every time. But this time, contrary to his original style, no hype was given to the Davos tour. What's haunting the Government of Andhra Pradesh? And what's going on in the minds of the investors? Earlier, Mr. Lokesh Nara, Minister, stated that investors are fearing Jagan's comeback. But why are these questions coming up, and why are such types of scary feelings being expressed by the investors? The NDA has a full majority, and Jagan's YSRC has only 11 MLAs. How can they expect Jagan's comeback when the government was formed only seven months ago and there are four years and three months left in its term? As per the sources, in Davos, the same discussions emerged. Companies have questioned whether there is a chance of Jagan's comeback. That is why they are hesitating to announce their new proposals. Though they desire to invest in Andhra Pradesh, previous experiences have become barricades to their thoughts. Mr. Y.S. Jaganmohan Reddy, when he came to power in 2019, demanded a review of PPAs (Power Purchase Agreements) signed during Mr. Naidu's regime, alleging that corruption had taken place. On this issue, multinational companies objected openly and complained to the Union Government of India. As the policy was decided by the Union Government, they acted accordingly. The Union Government openly warned Mr. Y.S. Jaganmohan Reddy on this matter, though it cooperated with him in many other political and policy matters, like the change of capital and others. What happened behind closed doors, we don't know, but it was ultimately settled with the intervention of the Union Government. This episode has made MNCs rethink investments in democratic India, where governments change periodically.



Investment Boost for Andhra Pradesh Tourism Sector -Minister Kandula Durgesh

Minister Kandula Durgesh recently announced a significant boost for the tourism sector in Andhra Pradesh, with the signing of MoUs for eight tourism projects worth Rs. 1,217 crore. These projects will result in the establishment of 825 new rooms in Visakhapatnam, Tirupati, Amaravati, and Alluri Seetharamaraju districts, creating over 2,500 jobs in the tourism industry. Minister Durgesh highlighted the ongoing Visakhapatnam Regional Tourism Conference, aimed at attracting investments to develop the tourism infrastructure in Uttarandhra. A major development, he revealed, is the creation of a cruise hub in Visakhapatnam, which is expected to transform the city into a real hub for entertainment and tourism.

The Minister also announced that the tourism sector in the state has been granted industry status, making it a prime time for investments. Tourism Secretary Ajay Jain praised Minister Durgesh for his active role in driving tourism development in the state, while APTDC Chairman Nookasani Balaji recognized the Minister's valuable support for the Tourism Department and Corporation.

Additionally, the Araku Chilli Festival brochure was released, showcasing the state's growing cultural tourism.



CM Naidu Urges TDP MPs to Focus on AP in Union Budget

Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu has called upon TDP MPs to ensure that Andhra Pradesh receives its due share in the Union Budget, urging them to prioritize the state's development needs. The call came during a Telugu Desam Parliamentary Party meeting held at his Undavalli residence on Tuesday, ahead of the Union Budget presentation scheduled for February 1.

Speaking at the meeting, Naidu highlighted key projects that the state has been promised by the central government, including Rs. 11,440 crore for the Vizag Steel Plant, Rs. 14,000 crore for the bulk drugs project in Nakkapalli, and Rs. 15,000 crore for Amaravati's construction. He instructed the MPs to work on securing additional funding and to ensure that pending issues under the Bifurcation Act are addressed promptly.

Emphasizing the state's vast coastline,



Naidu stressed that proper utilization could generate jobs and wealth for the state. He also pushed for the completion of several critical infrastructure projects, including the Nadikudi-Srikalahasti railway line and the Polavaram project. Furthermore, he urged MPs to engage with local MLAs and constit-

uency leaders to ensure that the needs of the people are represented effectively in the Union Budget.

Minister Nara Lokesh joined the meeting, with MPs discussing strategies to boost the state's development by leveraging national schemes.

AP Govt Regularizes Suspension of Retired IPS Officer AB Venkateshwara Rao

The Andhra Pradesh government has taken a significant step by regularizing the suspension period of retired IPS officer AB Venkateshwara Rao (ABV). ABV, who faced severe difficulties during the tenure of the YSRCP government, has now found relief under the coalition government.

The government issued an official order on Tuesday, regularizing ABV's suspension periods, which occurred during the YSRCP regime. ABV was first suspended from February 2, 2020, to February 7, 2022, and again from June 28, 2022, to May 30, 2024. The new orders specify that his suspension periods are now recognized as part of his official service, and the full salary and allowances that would have been owed to him during these periods will be paid. Furthermore, the AP government also announced the withdrawal of the charges that had been filed against ABV under the previous administration. The former YS-RCP government had accused him of irregularities in the purchase of surveillance equipment from Israel, claiming that his son's company was involved in phone tapping. However, with the coalition government now in power, these charges have been dismissed, and further action against ABV has been stopped, marking a significant turning point for the retired officer.



Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy Announces Job Opportunities for

ISRO Set to Make History with 100th Mission Launch Today

Today marks a historic moment for India's space agency, ISRO, as it prepares to launch its 100th mission from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh. The mission is scheduled for lift-off at 6:23 am, and it will carry the navigation satellite NVS-02 onboard a Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV). This mission holds special significance as it is the first under the leadership of ISRO's new Chairman, V Narayanan, who took office on January 13, 2025. The satellite NVS-02, part of the second generation of the Navigation with Indian Constellation (NavIC), will help provide precise positioning, velocity, and timing services for users in India and regions up to 1,500 km beyond.

The GSLV-F15 rocket, featuring an indigenous Cryogenic upper stage, will carry the 2,250 kg satellite, which is set to play a key role in applications like maritime navigation, precision agriculture, fleet management, and Internet-of-Things (IoT) services.

This launch follows the success of the GSLV-F12 mission in May 2023, which placed the first satellite of the Nav-IC series, NVS-01, into orbit. With today's mission, ISRO continues to showcase its growing capabilities in space exploration.

Minister Atchannaidu Slams YCP Leaders Over Alleged Mismanagement and Unfulfilled Promises

Minister Kinjarapu Atchannaidu launched a scathing attack on YSRCP leaders, accusing them of hypocrisy and failure to act on key issues concerning Andhra Pradesh. Speaking to the media after inspecting arrangements for the Arasavalli Sri Surya Narayana Swamy Rathasaptami celebrations, Atchannaidu questioned the YCP leaders who had failed to secure space for the Visakhapatnam Railway Zone but were now criticizing CM Chandrababu Naidu for his recent Davos trip.

Atchannaidu clarified that the state had already attracted Rs. 16 lakh crore in investments before Chandrababu's visit to Davos. He emphasized that CM Chan-

drababu has become a "brand" for the state, akin to how Chennai represents Tamil Nadu and Bangalore represents Karnataka.

He further attacked the YCP for not having done anything substantial regarding the Visakhapatnam Steel Plant, and questioned why they had never approached the central government for its development. Atchannaidu also highlighted that the central government had allocated funds to the steel plant, which was previously on the privatization list, and planned to use the steel for building projects in Amaravati.

Minister Atchannaidu concluded by criticizing the YCP leadership, saying the party would eventually face political consequences for their failure to deliver on promises. He reminded the public that when the TDP took charge, the state was burdened with a debt of Rs. 14 lakh crore, a fact acknowledged by Niti Aayog. He condemned the YCP's attempts to shift focus to the Super Six schemes rather than addressing their failures.

The Rarest of Rare Doctrine and the Fate of Victims in India's Legal System





Forecasting Key Elements of Nirmala Sitharaman's Budget 2025

The Union Budget is one of the most anticipated events in India's fiscal calendar. It not only outlines the government's financial health but also provides insight into its future policy direction. The upcoming Budget 2025-2026, set to be presented by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on February 1, is expected to focus on key developmental programmes, policy reforms, and economic strategies to navigate the current challenges and promote growth.

The 2024-2025 Budget proposed a total expenditure of Rs 48.21 trillion, with expected revenues (both tax and non-tax) and non-debt capital receipts, including disinvestment proceeds, pegged at Rs 32.07 trillion. This left a fiscal deficit of Rs 16.13 trillion. Looking ahead to the 2025-2026 Budget, the government is expected to maintain a similar trajectory in terms of fiscal policy while introducing measures to improve revenue generation and fiscal management.

The gross tax receipts (GTRs) until November 2024 stood at Rs 22.61 trillion, reflecting a growth of 10.72%, aligning with the projections for the year. Specifically, the Goods and Services Tax (GST) growth of 9.1% and a slight contraction of 0.53% in corporate tax receipts indicate a mixed performance, impacted by macroeconomic factors and corporate sector dynamics. Given the ongoing trends, the government is likely to target Rs 28.41 trillion for net Centre's Tax Receipts (CTRs) for 2025-2026.

Justice Leila Seth, the first woman Chief cilessly, only worth a meager Rs 50,000 Justice of the Delhi High Court, once poignantly remarked, "She is first raped, then she has to tell the story to the policeman. Then she has to tell the story to the judge, then she is cross-examined on it. She is raped over and over again." These words resonate deeply in the tragic case of a young junior doctor from RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, whose life was cruelly taken while performing her duties in a place that should have guaranteed her safety. Her murderer has been sentenced to life imprisonment, a sentence that some argue fails to match the severity of his crime. The Sessions Court in Sealdah deemed this case not to be one of the "rarest of rare," despite the brutal nature of the crime. Is the cost of a young life, taken so mer-

compensation to the victim's family?

India's legal system follows an adversarial model, which involves opposing parties presenting their case to a neutral judge or jury. This system differs from the inquisitorial model used in countries like France and Germany, where judges play an active role in investigating cases. In India, the burden of proof lies with the prosecution, and the accused has the right to silence. In sentencing, Indian courts follow key principles such as proportionality, deterrence, rehabilitation, and retribution, with the death penalty reserved for only the most extreme cases. The introduction of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (2023), which replaced the Indi-

an Penal Code (IPC), highlights a shift in legal frameworks, providing guidelines for serious offenses like murder and treason. However, capital punishment in India is only imposed in the rarest of rare cases, a doctrine established by the Supreme Court in 1980. The concept of "rarest of rare" was solidified in the Bachan Singh v. State of Punjab (1980) case, where the Supreme Court set forth criteria to determine when death penalty is appropriate. Factors such as the brutality of the crime, the offender's history, and the possibility of rehabilitation influence sentencing. Cases like Machhi Singh v. State of Punjab (1983), where the brutal slaughter of 17 family members was deemed beyond the scope of life imprisonment, led to the confirmation of the death penalty.

While the precise numbers will be revealed in the Budget, analysts predict that the government will continue to scale up ongoing flagship programs and announce new development initiatives aimed at spurring economic growth and addressing socio-economic challenges. Given the global uncertainties and domestic economic pressures, the Budget will also likely include measures to boost investment, job creation, and social welfare.

In terms of fiscal policy, the government is expected to take a cautious approach to ensure that revenue targets are met while managing inflationary pressures. The Budget may also prioritize key sectors such as infrastructure, healthcare, and education, along with digital economy initiatives and green energy projects, which have become increasingly important in the post-pandemic recovery phase.

The Budget 2025-2026, while maintaining continuity in fiscal policy, is likely to signal the government's commitment to long-term economic stability and sustainable growth, ensuring that India's recovery from the pandemic remains robust and inclusive.

India-China Relations: Who's Shaping the Narrative?

India's Foreign Secretary, Vikram Misri, recently visited China for a two-day trip aimed at discussing the future of bilateral relations, which have been tense following a nearly four-year military standoff. Both countries have made moves toward normalizing ties, but the underlying issues are far from resolved.

The relationship between India and China soured significantly in 2020 when Beijing unilaterally attempted to alter the status quo along the Line of Actual Control (LAC), leading to casualties on both sides. India responded firmly, emphasizing that peace and stability along the border would define the broader relationship. As a result, a series of measures were enacted, including banning nearly 300 Chinese



mobile apps, halting direct flights, imposing strict visa restrictions, and reviewing educational cooperation. The However, since the disengagement in focus shifted to safeguarding national security over economic or technologi-

cal engagements.

that had been frozen for years. The Special Representatives (SRs) mechanism has been revived, aimed at resolving the border issue. Notably, pilgrimages to Kailash Mansarovar in Tibet will resume, and discussions on hydrological data sharing and transnational river cooperation are advancing. Plans to restart direct air services are also in the works, signaling a move toward economic and cultural revitalization.

Despite these positive developments, several concerns remain. The weaponry amassed along the border during the standoff has not been withdrawn, raising questions about China's long-term intentions. Indian military officials have cautioned that while the situation in Eastern Ladakh is stable, both sides remain in a "degree of standoff." Additionally, the creation of no-patrol zones and the ongoing presence of military forces indicate that full disengagement may not be complete.

Beyond the military concerns, China's actions in other domains continue to be troubling. Beijing has proposed carving out new counties in Xinjiang that include parts of Ladakh, and its ambitious hydropower projects on the Brahmaputra River in Tibet continue to raise alarms in India. Diplomatic protests have been lodged, but the strategic competition continues to simmer beneath the surface. China's narrative, shaped by its strategic class, seems to suggest that India's engagement with China is driven by vulnerability, with concerns about Chinese corporations hurting the Indian economy.

The Unified Payments Interface (UPI) has achieved remarkable growth in India, now accounting for an astounding 83% of the country's digital payment volume in 2024, up from just 34% in 2019. This surge represents an impressive cumulative annual growth rate (CAGR) of 74% over the past five years, according to the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) latest payment system report. This equates to a CAGR of 89.3% in terms of transaction volume and 86.5% in transaction value.

J&K CM Reacts to UCC Implementation in Uttarakhand and Waqf Bill Amendments

Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah stated on Tuesday that it is ultimately Parliament, not individual Union Territories or states, that will make the final decision regarding the implementation of the Uniform Civil Code (UCC) and the Waqf (Amendment) Bill. His comments followed Uttarakhand's decision to implement the UCC, with the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) fulfilling a key promise made during the 2022 assembly elections.

Omar Abdullah emphasized that the decision on UCC and the Waqf Bill lies with Parliament, not individual states or UTs. Uttarakhand became the first state to implement the UCC, fulfilling a major BJP election commitment.

The Joint Parliamentary Committee examining the Waqf Bill has accepted all amendments proposed by BJP-NDA members, rejecting opposition suggestions.

Abdullah reacted to Uttarakhand's move by stating, "Let them do what they want to do till a law is enacted for the country. Finally, it is Parliament which will decide on



this and not the individual UTs or States." His remarks underline the ongoing debate over the UCC, which aims to implement a uniform set of laws governing personal matters such as marriage, inheritance, and adoption across India.

Regarding the Waqf Bill, Abdullah noted that the Joint Parliamentary Committee is still deliberating and no final decision has been made by the government. The committee, in recent discussions, adopted the amendments proposed by the BJP-led NDA members, but rejected changes suggested by opposition members. Abdullah also referred to a recent meeting between Hurriyat Conference chairman Mirwaiz Umar Farooq and the committee, where Farooq expressed his viewpoint on the matter.

Serbian Prime Minister Resigns Amid Protests Over Train Station Collapse

The ignited a wave of public outrage over the collapse of the train station roof, following extensive renovations, became the flashpoint for widespread dissatisfaction with the government's handling of construction projects and concerns about corruption in the country's infrastructure sector. These protests reflected long-standing grievances about the lack of oversight on major projects and the



slow pace of accountability.

Take your abuela (grandmother) with you." This remark quickly gained traction online, adding fuel to the fire of debate over the issue.

The backlash Selena faced prompted her to post another Story, where she expressed frustration, saying, "Apparently it's not ok to show empathy for people," though this message was also deleted shortly afterward.

Selena has long been an advocate for immigration rights, using her platform to raise awareness about the challenges faced by undocumented individuals. In 2019, she produced a Netflix documentary titled Living Undocumented, which highlights the stories of eight undocumented families living in the United States under Trump's administration. The documentary showcases her ongoing commitment to shedding light on the struggles of immigrants.

Selena's personal connection to the issue is rooted in her own family history. In an interview with TIME magazine in October 2019, she shared how her aunt crossed the US-Mexico border in the 1970s, followed by her grandparents, a journey that has shaped her understanding of immigration issues.

DeepSeek AI sends Shockwaves through US Tech Firms

On Monday, Chinese startup DeepSeek announced that it would temporarily limit registrations for its AI assistant due to a cyberattack. The disruption comes after the company's AI model became unexpectedly popular, climbing to the top of the Apple App Store's free applications list in the United States. The company also faced significant outages, marking its longest downtime in around 90 days, coinciding with its newfound popularity.

DeepSeek, which launched its free AI assistant on January 10, has garnered attention for offering a model that uses less data and costs significantly less than its competitors. Powered by the DeepSeek-V3, which its creators claim outperforms many open-source models and rivals advanced closed-source models, the AI assistant has quickly become a favorite among US users. According to Sensor Tower, app data research firm, the model's rapid rise reflects a significant shift in the AI landscape, challenging long-standing views on the dominance of US companies and the effectiveness of US export controls targeting China's tech industry.



The popularity of DeepSeek's AI assistant a significant mark on Silicon Valley, highlights a major breakthrough for the Hangzhou-based startup, founded in 2023. The company's success has led to discussions in the US tech industry about the effectiveness of export controls on Chinese AI models. DeepSeek's AI application has reportedly been trained using Nvidia's H800 chips, which cost the company under \$6 million, a relatively low expense compared to its US counterparts. While some have disputed these claims, the success of DeepSeek's model has prompted US tech executives to question whether export controls on AI-related chips are truly effective.

DeepSeek's rise also coincides with in-

creased scrutiny of US technology firms' reliance on advanced chips to power AI models. Despite the US government's expanded chip bans, DeepSeek's breakthrough has shown that Chinese companies can still develop competitive AI models with comparatively lower costs, undermining the US's control over AI capabilities.

Little is known about DeepSeek beyond its impressive technological achievements, but the company's ability to rival US AI models has left

prompting US executives to reconsider their stance on China's technological advancements.

Trump Encourages Bidding War for TikTok as Microsoft **Considers Acquisition**

US President Donald Trump revealed that Microsoft is in talks to acquire TikTok, urging for a bidding war over the popular social media app. This comes after a series of national security concerns raised about the app's Chinese owner, ByteDance. Despite these developments, Microsoft declined to comment, and both TikTok and ByteDance have not responded outside of regular business hours.

TikTok, with around 170 million users in the US, faced a brief outage before a law requiring ByteDance to sell the app or face a national ban took effect on January 19. President Trump signed an executive order on January 20, delaying the enforcement of this law for 75 days. He stated that he was in talks with multiple parties regarding the app's acquisition and anticipated making a decision within 30 days.

Trump previously indicated that he would be open to allowing billionaire Elon Musk to purchase TikTok. However, Musk has not commented on the offer, leaving speculation to linger. In the latest developments, AI startup Perplexity AI has reportedly proposed a merger with TikTok, with the US government potentially holding up to half of the newly formed company. This proposal adds another layer to the ongoing negotiations.





India's Electronics Manufacturing Shifts Focus to Component Production with EMS 2.0



India is taking a significant step forward in its electronics manufacturing sector by advancing to the second phase of its electronics manufacturing journey, referred to as Electronics Manufacturing Services (EMS) 2.0. This phase will emphasize the actual manufacturing of electronic components, unlike EMS 1.0, which primarily focused on assembling these components.

According to a report by Phillip Capital, the Indian government is working on introducing a new Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for electronic components. This new scheme aims to increase value addition in the sector to 35-40%, a significant jump from the current 18-20% under the ongoing electronics manufactur-

ing incentive programs. The goal is to make India a more competitive destination for electronics manufacturing by promoting local production and reducing dependence on costly imports, which are often subject to tariffs and other barriers.

While India has made considerable progress in electronics assembly, particularly in mobile and consumer electronics, it still relies heavily on imports for component manufacturing and design. EMS 2.0 will address this gap by shifting the focus toward manufacturing components locally, thus enhancing India's capabilities in this critical area.

To support this shift, the government had previously launched the Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS), which offers a 25% upfront capital expenditure incentive to encourage investment in component manufacturing. However, both the PLI for Large-Scale Electronics Manufacturing and the SPECS scheme are approaching their deadlines, making the introduction of a new subsidy scheme vital for the future of component production.

EMS 2.0 is seen as a crucial step in India's ambition to become a global hub for electronics manufacturing, moving beyond assembly to a more robust and self-sustaining industry. This new phase will further enhance India's manufacturing capabilities, positioning the country as a key player in the global electronics market.

Industrialists Optimistic About India's Growth Ahead of Union Budget 2025-26

Ahead of the Union Budget 2025-26, a survey conducted by the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) has revealed that 64% of industrialists are optimistic about India's economic growth. The survey, conducted between late December 2024 and mid-January 2025, indicates that nearly 60% of the participants expect the GDP growth rate for 2025-26 to fall between 6.5% and 6.9%. While this represents a moderation from the robust 8% growth in 2023-24, it aligns with global economic challenges and persistent external headwinds.



UPI's Growth in India: A Digital Payment Revolution



The Unified Payments Interface (UPI) has emerged as the dominant force in India's digital payment landscape, experiencing an extraordinary surge in adoption. According to the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) latest payment system report, UPI's share of digital payments has skyrocketed from 34% in 2019 to an impressive 83% in 2024. This represents a remarkable CAGR (Cumulative Average Growth Rate) of 74% over the past five years, underscoring the rapid acceptance and success of UPI as a payment solution.

During the same period, other traditional payment methods such as RTGS, NEFT, IMPS, credit cards, and debit cards saw a notable decline, with their combined share dropping from 66% to just 17%. The report attri-

Tiger Urine for Sale in China: Controversy Surrounds Alleged Medicinal Claims

The sale of ti-**I** ger urine at a popular wildlife zoo in China is sparking significant debate. Ya'an Bifengxia Wildlife Zoo, located in the Sichuan province, has been offering bottles of Siberian tiger urine, claiming it has therapeutic properties. Accord-

ing to a report by the *South China Morning Post*, each 250-gram bottle is sold for 50 yuan (approximately Rs 596). Despite no scientific evidence backing these claims, the zoo asserts that the tiger urine can help alleviate conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis, muscle pain, and sprains.

The zoo provides a guide with instructions on how to use the urine. The purported remedy involves mixing the urine with white wine and ginger, applying it to the affected area for relief. The zoo even suggests that the urine may be ingested, although it advises caution for individuals with allergies. However, questions remain about the safety and hygiene of this practice. A staff member at the zoo revealed that the urine is collected in a basin, but it remains unclear whether the substance is properly disinfected before being sold to customers.

While the sales of tiger urine are reportedly limited to an average of two bottles per day, the zoo's actions are raising concerns among animal rights advocates and the broader public. The zoo's previous use of tiger urine as a prize in a reality show back in 2014 has also drawn criticism for trivializing animal exploitation. Despite these controversies, the practice continues to attract attention from visitors eager to try what is marketed as a traditional remedy.

The sale of animal-derived products like tiger urine highlights ongoing debates around traditional medicine and animal conservation. Many experts argue that such practices may contribute to the illegal wildlife trade and harm endangered species like the Siberian tiger, which is already facing significant threats to its survival.

L cation Report (ASER) has revealed some significant insights into the use of smartphones and education trends among children in rural India. According to the 2024 ASER findings, over 82% of children aged 14 to 16 are familiar with using smartphones, but only 57% of them actively use the devices for educational purposes.

The report highlights a major improvement in the educational landscape since the The Annual Status of Edupandemic, including a notable recovery from learning losses experienced during the COVID-19 crisis. Learning levels in primary classes are reportedly higher than before, and the percentage of children enrolled in Class 1 who are underage has dropped to its lowest level ever at 16.7%.

Another key takeaway from the ASER 2023 findings is that the proportion of children aged 6 to 14 enrolled in government schools has nearly returned to the levels seen in 2018, signaling a steady recovery. However, the report also notes that the surge in government school enrollments seen during the pandemic has started to reverse in recent years.

Additionally, the ASER 2023 data points to a high rate of school enrollment among older children, with over 86.8% of youngsters aged 14 to 18 enrolled in educational institutions. More than half of these students have chosen the humanities stream, a trend that signals a shift in educational preferences.

What is ASER?

cation Report (ASER) is a citizen-led household survey that provides insights into the schooling and learning status of children in rural India. First conducted in 2005, the survey has been a vital tool in tracking education trends, with a focus on enrollment, learning outcomes, and access to educational resources. It includes data on preschool and school enrollment for children aged 3 to 16, as well as assessments of foundational reading and arithmetic skills for children aged 5 to 16.

These findings help shape policies and initiatives aimed at improving education quality in rural areas of India.

This breakthrough could have profound implications for how we understand the behavior of supermassive black holes and their influence on galaxy formation.


