

Hyderabad, Jan 29: The Meerpet murder case has taken a grim turn with the police reconstructing the scene, revealing the chilling details of how Gurumurthy killed his wife, Venkata Madhavi. The investigation has now shifted from a missing person case to a confirmed murder.

On January 15, Gurumurthy murdered Madhavi in a brutal manner, dismembering her body into pieces al of Madhavi's body. Gurumurthy which he then cooked using a cooker and an electric heater. He disposed of the remains, including grinding the bones into powder and discarding all traces of his crime.

In a disturbing cover-up, Gurumurthy filed a missing person report on due to its shocking details.

January 16, feigning ignorance. However, his actions were inspired by the thriller movie 'Sookshmadarshini', where a similar method of body disposal was shown. His plan included dissolving the body in acid, a technique he tried to replicate.

The police detained Gurumurthy after uncovering his marital issues, leading to his confession. Evidence was collected based on his statements, including a stove, knife, roller, bucket, heater, clothes, and cleaning materials used during the crime. An examination of his call logs post-murder showed eight calls, one to his sister in Badangpet, with further inquiries into these connections ongoing. Additionally, Gurumurthy had booked movie tickets for 'Sankranthiki Yaalaam' the day after the murder, which didn't hold as an alibi.

CP Sudheer Babu described the sequence of events, from the initial altercation to the gruesome disposhit Madhavi, causing her death, and then meticulously planned the body's destruction to avoid detection.

Hyderabad, **Jan 29** : Deputy Chief Minister Bhatti Vikramarka Mallu, speaking at an education meeting in Chennai on Tuesday, addressed several key issues related to Telangana's education system, governance, and ongoing investigations. In response to allegations regarding the

misuse of public funds in the Formula E car race affair, the Deputy CM clarified that a case had been registered against the then-minister KTR, and a departmental inquiry is currently underway. He assured that anyone with relevant information can come forward to the investigating agencies.

The Deputy CM highlighted the Telangana government's commitment to enhancing the state's education

sector. He mentioned the allocation of 25,000 crores for education this financial year, with plans for further increases. Bhatti Vikramarka also emphasized the creation of 60 Young India International Residential Schools, which will be built with international standards on 20-25 acres of land. These schools will provide world-class education, accommodation for staff, and ample sports facilities like cricket and football fields.

RS Praveen Files Complaint **Against CM Revanth**

Hyderabad, Jan 29: Former IPS officer and BRS leader RS Praveen Kumar has filed a complaint against Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, urging the police to name him as the main accused in the Formula E Race case. Kumar alleged that Revanth Reddy's actions led to the loss of several potential investments in Telangana. Meanwhile, the Congress government has been investigating alleged corruption in the Formula E Race held during the previous BRS regime, focusing on former Minister K.T. Rama Rao's (KTR) role. As part of the probe, KTR recently appeared before the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) for questioning.

The Formula E Race, held in Hyderabad, had drawn national attention. The then



BRS government reportedly paid ₹45.71 crore to UK-based Formula E Operations (FEO) through the Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority (HMDA). Following this, MAUD Principal Secretary Danakishore lodged a complaint with the ACB, alleging financial irregularities. As a result, the ACB and ED have registered cases against KTR, senior IAS officer Arvind Kumar, and retired HMDA Chief Engineer BLN Reddy, with investigations ongoing.

Harish Rao Challenges Government's **Investment Figures**

Hyderabad, Jan 29: Ex Finance Minister Harish Rao has sharply criticized CM Revanth Reddy following his press meet, questioning the sudden invitation for a Davos visit and calling out the claims of large-scale investments in the state. In a tweet, Harish Rao expressed skepti-



cism about the recent invitation to Davos, which he noted had already passed. He questioned the authenticity of the investments touted by the Chief Minister, stating that the MoUs signed at Davos were merely expressions of interest and that real investments would require open tenders.

Harish Rao further took aim at Finance Minister Bhatti Vikramarka's statement claiming Rs. 1.82 lakh crore in investments, asking if it was true. He criticized the government's investment narrative, accusing them of propagating empty claims that lacked substance. Harish rao also questioned the priority of the government, pointing out that the real issues affecting the people, such as farmer debt relief, were being ignored.

Rao slammed Revanth Reddy for referring to farmer assurance programs as a "small panchayat" and mocked the repeated delays in fulfilling promises. He called the ongoing extensions of deadlines for farmer relief—previously promised by Sankranti and now extended to March 31—mere "empty propaganda." He questioned the government's priorities, suggesting that while investments and foreign funds were being emphasized, the plight of farmers and their debt concerns were being neglected.

Ilayya questioned KTR's moral authority to criticize leaders like Komatireddy and Uttam Kumar Reddy, accusing him of being involved in questionable activities. He referred to KTR as a "thief" caught in the crossfire of the Formula E car race controversy, suggesting that a case would soon be filed against him, similar to how a thief is dealt with by the law.

Furthermore, Ilayya claimed that KTR was using farmers to restore his tarnished image, asserting that the Congress government is committed to supporting both farmers and farm laborers. He concluded by stating that KTR's downfall began in Nalgonda, signaling the start of his political decline.

Vizag Kidney Scam Expands to Hyderabad

Key Accused Resumes Illegal Surgeries Kidney Recipients Still Unknown Special Teams Hunt for More Accused

Hyderabad, Jan 29: The sensational Visakhapatnam kidney racket, which first came to light in May 2023, has now been linked to a similar illegal network operating in Hyderabad. The Rachakonda police revealed that Dr. Perumalla Rajasekhar, the prime accused in the Visakhapatnam case, has resumed his illegal operations in Hyderabad after being jailed in Andhra Pradesh.

From Visakhapatnam to Hyderabad: A Widening Network

The case initially surfaced in the Pendurthi area of Visakhapatnam when an illegal kidney transplant was discovered. Investigations revealed that a victim's kidney had been unlawfully removed and transplanted into a recipient from Chhattisgarh. The police arrested Dr. Rajasekhar, along with ten others, in connection with the racket.

However, despite his imprisonment, Rajasekhar allegedly revived his illegal business in Hyderabad in 2024, operating through Alaknanda Hospital under the directives of a person identified as Pawan Gang. Police

Analysts believe that until law enforcement uncovers the full extent of the racket, the case will remain shrouded in mystery. Man Injured in Tank **Bund Boat Fire** Succumbs to Injuries

Hyderabad, Jan 29: The man injured in the Tank Bund boat fire incident succumbed to his injuries while undergoing treatment at a hospital. Doctors at Yashoda Hospital in Secunderabad confirmed his death on Tuesday morning.

The tragic incident occurred on January 26 during a patriotic event, "Bharat Mata Harathi," organized near People's Plaza at Tank Bund under the supervision of Union Minister Kishan Reddy as part of Republic Day celebrations.

The accident took place late at night when fireworks ignited a fire on a boat loaded with firecrackers. Ganapati, who suffered severe burns covering 80% of his body, had been admitted to Yashoda Hospital for treatment but succumbed to his injuries.

Another young man went missing during the incident, and authorities have yet to locate him. Rescue teams continue their efforts to find the missing individual. The incident has raised concerns about safety measures during such events. An investigation is underway to determine the cause of the fire and establish accountability.

ly, he filed a writ petition in the Delhi High Court against the Telangana police, citing an unlawful arrest attempt and expressing fears for his safety. The High Court directed the Telangana DGP to submit a reply within six



2 Telangana Cops Arrested for Rs 1.4 Lakh **Bribe in PDS Rice Scam**

Hyderabad, Jan 29: Two Telangana police officers, including a sub-inspector and a constable, were arrested by the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) for allegedly demanding and accepting a bribe of Rs 1.4 lakh in connection with a Public Distribution System (PDS) rice scam.

The accused, Vukkurthy Suresh, a sub-inspector at Thirumalagiri police station in Suryapet, and Nagaraju, a constable, allegedly sought a bribe to prevent the complainant's arrest in a ration rice case. According to reports, the two officers demanded Rs 3 lakh but eventually accepted Rs 1.4 lakh, with Rs 1 lakh going to the sub-inspector and Rs 40,000 to the constable.

The first installment of Rs 30,000 was paid via PhonePe on January 25, followed by an additional Rs 70,000 on January 28. A chemical test confirmed the presence of the bribe money on the constable's fingers.

In a separate case, an ACB operation also led to the arrest of a sub-inspector and two constables from Hyderabad police for accepting bribes to close a case.

The ACB has urged the public to report bribery incidents via their toll-free helpline, 1064.

Forecasting Key Elements of Nirmala Sitharaman's **Budget 2025**

The Union Budget is one of the most anticipated events in India's fiscal calendar. It not only outlines the government's financial health but also provides insight into its future policy direction. The upcoming Budget 2025-2026, set to be presented by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on February 1, is expected to focus on key developmental programmes, policy reforms, and economic strategies to navigate the current challenges and promote growth.

The 2024-2025 Budget proposed a total expenditure of Rs 48.21 trillion, with expected revenues (both tax and non-tax) and non-debt capital receipts, including disinvestment proceeds, pegged at Rs 32.07 trillion. This left a fiscal deficit of Rs 16.13 trillion. Looking ahead to the 2025-2026 Budget, the government is expected to maintain a similar trajectory in terms of fiscal policy while introducing measures to improve revenue generation and fiscal management.

The gross tax receipts (GTRs) until November 2024 stood at Rs 22.61 trillion, reflecting a growth of 10.72%, aligning with the projections for the year. Specifically, the Goods and Services Tax (GST) growth of 9.1% and a slight contraction of 0.53% in corporate tax receipts indicate a mixed performance, impacted by macroeconomic factors and corporate sector dynamics. Given the ongoing trends, the government is likely to target Rs 28.41 trillion for net Centre's Tax Receipts (CTRs) for 2025-2026.

While the precise numbers will be revealed in the Budget, analysts predict that the government will continue to scale up ongoing flagship programs and announce new development initiatives aimed at spurring economic growth and addressing socio-economic challenges. Given the global uncertainties and domestic economic pressures, the Budget will also likely include measures to boost investment, job creation, and social welfare.

In terms of fiscal policy, the government is expected to take a cautious approach to ensure that revenue targets are met while managing inflationary pressures. The Budget may also prioritize key sectors such as infrastructure, healthcare, and education, along with digital economy initiatives and green energy projects, which have become increasingly important in the post-pandemic recovery phase.

The Budget 2025-2026, while maintaining continuity in fiscal policy, is likely to signal the government's commitment to long-term economic stability and sustainable growth, ensuring that India's recovery from the pandemic remains robust and inclusive.

Justice Leila Seth, the first woman Chief cilessly, only worth a meager Rs 50,000 Justice of the Delhi High Court, once poignantly remarked, "She is first raped, then she has to tell the story to the policeman. Then she has to tell the story to the judge, then she is cross-examined on it. She is raped over and over again." Her murderer has been sentenced to life imprisonment, a sentence that some argue fails to match the severity of his crime. India's legal system follows an adversarial model, which involves opposing parties presenting their case to a neutral judge or jury. This system differs from the inquisitorial model used in countries like France and Germany, where judges play an active role in investigating cases. In India, the burden of proof lies with the prosecution, and the accused has the right to silence. In sentencing, Indian courts follow key principles such as proportionality, deterrence, rehabilitation, and retribution, with the death penalty reserved for only the most extreme cases. The introduction of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (2023), which replaced the Indi-

an Penal Code (IPC), highlights a shift in legal frameworks, providing guidelines for serious offenses like murder and treason. However, capital punishment in India is only imposed in the rarest of rare cases, a doctrine established by the Supreme Court in 1980. The concept of "rarest of rare" was solidified in the Bachan Singh v. State of Punjab (1980) case, where the Supreme Court set forth criteria to determine when death penalty is appropriate. Factors such as the brutality of the crime, the offender's history, and the possibility of rehabilitation influence sentencing. Cases like Machhi Singh v. State of Punjab (1983), where the brutal slaughter of 17 family members was deemed beyond the scope of life imprisonment, led to the confirmation of the death penalty.

India-China Relations: Who's Shaping the Narrative?

India's Foreign Secretary, Vikram Misri, recently visited China for a two-day trip aimed at discussing the future of bilateral relations, which have been tense following a nearly four-year military standoff. Both countries have made moves toward normalizing ties, but the underlying issues are far from resolved.

The relationship between India and China soured significantly in 2020 when Beijing unilaterally attempted to alter the status quo along the Line of Actual Control (LAC), leading to casualties on both sides. India responded firmly, emphasizing that peace and stability along the border would define the broader relationship. As a result, a series of measures were enacted, including banning nearly 300 Chinese



mobile apps, halting direct flights, imposing strict visa restrictions, and reviewing educational cooperation. The However, since the disengagement in focus shifted to safeguarding national security over economic or technologi-

that had been frozen for years. The Special Representatives (SRs) mechanism has been revived, aimed at resolving the border issue. Plans to restart direct air services are also in the works, signaling a move toward economic and cultural revitalization.

Despite these positive developments, several concerns remain. The weaponry amassed along the border during the standoff has not been withdrawn, raising questions about China's long-term intentions. Indian military officials have cautioned that while the situation in Eastern Ladakh is stable, both sides remain in a "degree of standoff." Additionally, the creation of no-patrol zones and the ongoing presence of military forces indicate that full disengagement may not be complete.

Beyond the military concerns, China's actions in other domains continue to be troubling. Beijing has proposed carving out new counties in Xinjiang that include parts of Ladakh, and its ambitious hydropower projects on the Brahmaputra River in Tibet continue to raise alarms in India. Diplomatic protests have been lodged, but the strategic competition continues to simmer beneath the surface. China's narrative, shaped by its strategic class, seems to suggest that India's engagement with China is driven by vulnerability, with concerns about Chinese corporations hurting the Indian economy.

Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah stated on Tuesday that it is ultimately Parliament, not individual Union Territories or states, that will make the final decision regarding the implementation of the Uniform Civil Code (UCC) and the Waqf (Amendment) Bill. His comments followed Uttarakhand's decision to implement the UCC, with the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) fulfilling a key promise made during the 2022 assembly elections.

this and not the individual UTs or States." His remarks underline the ongoing debate over the UCC, which aims to implement a uniform set of laws governing personal matters such as marriage, inheritance, and adoption across India.

Regarding the Waqf Bill, Abdullah noted that the Joint Parliamentary Committee is still deliberating and no final decision has been made by the government. The committee, in recent discussions, adopted the amendments proposed by the BJP-led NDA members, but rejected changes suggested by opposition members. Abdullah also referred to a recent meeting between Hurriyat Conference chairman Mirwaiz Umar Farooq and the committee, where Farooq expressed his viewpoint on the matter.

Serbian Prime Minister Resigns Amid **Protests Over Train Station Collapse**

DeepSeek AI sends Shockwaves through US Tech Firms

On Monday, Chinese startup DeepSeek announced that it would temporarily limit registrations for its AI assistant due to a cyberattack. The disruption comes after the company's AI model became unexpectedly popular, climbing to the top of the Apple App Store's free applications list in the United States. The company also faced significant outages, marking its longest downtime in around 90 days, coinciding with its newfound popularity.

DeepSeek, which launched its free AI assistant on January 10, has garnered attention for offering a model that uses less data and costs significantly less than its competitors. Powered by the DeepSeek-V3, which its creators claim outperforms many open-source models and rivals advanced closed-source models, the AI assistant has quickly become a favorite among US users. According to Sensor Tower, app data research firm, the model's rapid rise reflects a significant shift in the AI landscape, challenging long-standing views on the dominance of US companies and the effectiveness of US export controls targeting China's tech industry.



The popularity of DeepSeek's AI assistant a significant mark on Silicon Valley, highlights a major breakthrough for the Hangzhou-based startup, founded in 2023. The company's success has led to discussions in the US tech industry about the effectiveness of export controls on Chinese AI models. DeepSeek's AI application has reportedly been trained using Nvidia's H800 chips, which cost the company under \$6 million, a relatively low expense compared to its US counterparts. While some have disputed these claims, the success of DeepSeek's model has prompted US tech executives to question whether export controls on AI-related chips are truly effective.

DeepSeek's rise also coincides with in-

creased scrutiny of US technology firms' reliance on advanced chips to power AI models. Despite the US government's expanded chip bans, DeepSeek's breakthrough has shown that Chinese companies can still develop competitive AI models with comparatively lower costs, undermining the US's control over AI capabilities.

Take your abuela (grandmother) with you." This remark quickly gained traction online, adding fuel to the fire of debate over the issue.

The backlash Selena faced prompted her to post another Story, where she expressed frustration, saying, "Apparently it's not ok to show empathy for people," though this message was also deleted shortly af-

Selena has long been an advocate for immigration rights, using her platform to raise awareness about the challenges faced by undocumented individuals. In 2019, she produced a Netflix documentary titled Living Undocumented, which highlights the stories of eight undocumented families living in the United States under Trump's administration. The documentary showcases her ongoing commitment to shedding light on the struggles of immigrants.

Trump Encourages Bidding War for TikTok as Microsoft **Considers Acquisition**

US President Donald Trump revealed that Microsoft is in talks to acquire TikTok, urging for a bidding war over the popular social media app. This comes after a series of national security concerns raised about the app's Chinese owner, ByteDance. Despite these developments, Microsoft declined to comment, and both TikTok and ByteDance have not responded outside of regular business hours.

TikTok, with around 170 million users in the US, faced a brief outage before a law requiring ByteDance to sell the app or face a national ban took effect on January 19. President Trump signed an executive order on January 20, delaying the enforcement of this law for 75 days. He stated that he was in talks with multiple parties regarding the app's acquisition and anticipated making a decision within 30 days.

Trump previously indicated that he would be open to allowing billionaire Elon Musk to purchase TikTok. However, Musk has not commented on the offer, leaving speculation to linger. In the latest developments, AI startup Perplexity AI has reportedly proposed a merger with TikTok, with the US government potentially holding up to half of the newly formed company. This proposal adds another layer to the ongoing negotiations.

India's Electronics Manufacturing Shifts Focus to Component Production with EMS 2.0



India is taking a significant step forward in its electronics manufacturing sector by advancing to the second phase of its electronics manufacturing journey, referred to as Electronics Manufacturing Services (EMS) 2.0. This phase will emphasize the actual manufacturing of electronic components, unlike EMS 1.0, which primarily focused on assembling these components.

According to a report by Phillip Capital, the Indian government is working on introducing a new Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for electronic components. This new scheme aims to increase value addition in the sector to 35-40%, a significant jump from the current 18-20% under the ongoing electronics manufactur-

ing incentive programs. The goal is to make India a more competitive destination for electronics manufacturing by promoting local production and reducing dependence on costly imports, which are often subject to tariffs and other barriers.

While India has made considerable progress in electronics assembly, particularly in mobile and consumer electronics, it still relies heavily on imports for component manufacturing and design. EMS 2.0 will address this gap by shifting the focus toward manufacturing components locally, thus enhancing India's capabilities in this

To support this shift, the government had previously launched the Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS), which offers a 25% upfront capital expenditure incentive to encourage investment in component manufacturing. However, both the PLI for Large-Scale Electronics Manufacturing and the SPECS scheme are approaching their deadlines, making the introduction of a new subsidy scheme vital for the future of component production.

EMS 2.0 is seen as a crucial step in India's ambition to become a global hub for electronics manufacturing, moving beyond assembly to a more robust and self-sustaining industry. This new phase will further enhance India's manufacturing capabilities, positioning the country as a key player in the global electronics market.

Industrialists Optimistic About India's Growth Ahead of Union Budget 2025-26

Ahead of the Union Budget 2025-26, a survey conducted by the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) has revealed that 64% of industrialists are optimistic about India's economic growth. The survey, conducted between late December 2024 and mid-January 2025, indicates that nearly 60% of the participants expect the GDP growth rate for 2025-26 to fall between 6.5% and 6.9%. While this represents a moderation from the robust 8% growth in 2023-24, it aligns with global economic challenges and persistent external headwinds.

Key takeaways from the survey include an expectation for the government to maintain its commitment to fiscal consolidation. Around 47% of participants believe the government will meet its fiscal deficit target of 4.9% for FY 2024-25, with 24% expecting even better results.

The survey also highlighted the importance of continuing public capital expenditure (capex) to sustain economic growth. 68% of respondents called for a significant focus on increasing capex, with many suggesting a 15% rise in allocation for FY 2025-26. Tiger Urine for Sale in China: **Controversy Surrounds Alleged Medicinal Claims**

The sale of ti-**I** ger urine at a popular wildlife zoo in China is sparking significant debate. Ya'an Bifengxia Wildlife Zoo, located in the Sichuan province, has been offering bottles of Siberian tiger urine, claiming it has therapeutic properties. Accord-



ing to a report by the *South China Morning Post*, each 250-gram bottle is sold for 50 yuan (approximately Rs 596). Despite no scientific evidence backing these claims, the zoo asserts that the tiger urine can help alleviate conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis, muscle pain, and sprains.

The zoo provides a guide with instructions on how to use the urine. The purported remedy involves mixing the urine with white wine and ginger, applying it to the affected area for relief. The zoo even suggests that the urine may be ingested, although it advises caution for individuals with allergies. However, questions remain about the safety and hygiene of this practice. A staff member at the zoo revealed that the urine is collected in a basin, but it remains unclear whether the substance is properly disinfected before being sold to customers.

While the sales of tiger urine are reportedly limited to an average of two bottles per day, the zoo's actions are raising concerns among animal rights advocates and the broader public. The zoo's previous use of tiger urine as a prize in a reality show back in 2014 has also drawn criticism for trivializing animal exploitation. Despite these controversies, the practice continues to attract attention from visitors eager to try what is marketed as a traditional remedy.

The sale of animal-derived products like tiger urine highlights ongoing debates around traditional medicine and animal conservation. Many experts argue that such practices may contribute to the illegal wildlife trade and harm endangered species like the Siberian tiger, which is already facing significant threats to its survival.

82% of Children Aged 14-16 Know How to **Use Smartphones: ASER Report**



The Annual Status of Edu-**L** cation Report (ASER) has revealed some significant insights into the use of smartphones and education trends among children in rural India. According to the 2024 ASER findings, over 82% of children aged 14 to 16 are familiar with using smartphones, but only 57% of them actively use the devices for educational pur-

The report highlights a major improvement in the educational landscape since the The Annual Status of Edupandemic, including a notable recovery from learning losses experienced during the COVID-19 crisis. Learning levels in primary classes are reportedly higher than before, and the percentage of children enrolled in Class 1 who are underage has dropped to its lowest level ever at 16.7%.

Another key takeaway from the ASER 2023 findings is that the proportion of children aged 6 to 14 enrolled in government schools has nearly returned to the levels seen in 2018, signaling a steady recovery. However, the report also notes that the surge in government school enrollments seen during the pandemic has started to reverse in recent years.

Additionally, the ASER 2023 data points to a high rate of school enrollment among older children, with over 86.8% of youngsters aged 14 to 18 enrolled in educational institutions. More than half of these students have chosen the humanities stream, a trend that signals a shift in educational preferences.

What is ASER?

cation Report (ASER) is a citizen-led household survey that provides insights into the schooling and learning status of children in rural India. First conducted in 2005, the survey has been a vital tool in tracking education trends, with a focus on enrollment, learning outcomes, and access to educational resources. It includes data on preschool and school enrollment for children aged 3 to 16, as well as assessments of foundational reading and arithmetic skills for children aged 5 to 16.

These findings help shape policies and initiatives aimed at improving education quality in rural areas of India.

NASA Study Reveals How Black Holes "Create Their Meals" Through Outbursts

Anew study from NASA has uncovered a fascinating process through which black holes in galaxy clusters "create their meals" by cooling down surrounding gas. The research, led by Valeria Olivares from the University of Santiago de Chile, analyzed data from NASA's Chandra X-ray Observatory and the Very Large Telescope (VLT). It focuses on seven galaxy clusters, including the well-

known Perseus and Centaurus clusters, where supermassive black holes reside at their centers.

These black holes, with masses ranging from millions to billions of times that of the Sun, play a crucial role in regulating the environment of their host galaxies. The study reveals that black holes cause internal outbursts that cool down the surrounding gas, leading to the formation of warm filaments. These filaments aid in the black holes' growth by drawing gas

toward their centers, where it serves as their "meal."

The study also highlights how turbulence
The research, published in Nature Asin the surrounding gas boosts the triggering of these outbursts, setting off a cycle of repeated gas cooling and feeding. As the gas cools, it feeds the black holes, triggering another outburst and continuing the cycle. This process, as identified in the study, is fundamental to understanding the connection between the brightness of hot and warm gas filaments found at the

centers of galaxy clusters.

identified, for the first time, a direct relationship between the brightness of hot and warm gas filaments, especially in areas with bright hot gas, which also show similar brightness in the warm gas. Interestingly, these filaments bear resemblance to the trailing structures seen in jellyfish galaxies, which shed gas while moving through space, creating similar patterns. This surprising link

suggests that a common cosmic process may govern both phenomena.




