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
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Obscene New Year's Rave Party Sparks Outrage in Mandapet

Video of Semi-Nude Dances and Alcohol Consumption Goes Viral; Jana Sena Party's Alleged Involvement Draws Criticism

A shocking video circulating on social media has sparked outrage, claiming that a rave party was held in Mandapet town of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema district during New Year celebrations.

The footage shows women dancing in semi-nude attire, consuming alcohol, while a mix of young and old men join in. The video has quickly gone viral, raising concerns about the nature of the event and the involvement of local political figures. Police investigations have yet to confirm the exact location

or timing of the rave party, although sources indicate that some key individuals involved in organizing the event include Medida Pullaji, Muthu, Yerramsetty Sarvesh, Gurumalla Eswar Rao, Velpur Muthu, Darla Nagu, and Crane, many of whom are allegedly affiliated with the Jana Sena party.

Kamepalli Tulasibabu, an accused in the custodial torture case of Andhra Pradesh Deputy Speaker Raghuramakrishna Raju, has avoided the police investigation. In a letter addressed to Prakasam District SP Damodar, Tulasibabu stated that he would not be able to attend Friday's questioning and requested additional time.

Tulasibabu faces allegations of torturing Raghuramakrishna Raju, who had undergone a heart operation, by allegedly sitting on his chest during custodial interrogation.

On the other hand, Raghuramakrishna Raju has already written a letter to the district SP asking not to consider Tulasibabu's request for time instead of attending the hearing. In his letter, Raju recounted the night of May 14, 2021, when he was subjected to custodial torture by CID officers. He claimed that witnesses informed him that a tall man weighing 115 kg had sat on his chest, and he believes that person to be Tulasibabu. Raju stated that he would be able to recall Tulasibabu's presence when the accused is called



for questioning.

Meanwhile, the court has dismissed the anticipatory bail petition filed by Dr. Prabhavathi, the fifth accused in the case. Rajendra Prasad, Joint Director of Prosecutions, informed the court that Dr. Prabhavathi had failed to uphold her constitutional duties and had colluded with the other accused. After considering all the facts, the court de-

Allu Arjun Secures Regular Bail in Theatre Stampede Case

Actor Allu Arjun has been granted regular bail by a local court in connection with the tragic stampede incident at a Hyderabad theatre during the premiere of his film Pushpa 2: The Rule. The incident, which occurred on December 4, resulted in the death of a 35-year-old woman and the hospitalization of her nineyear-old son due to asphyxiation. Allu Arjun was arrested on December 13 but

was released a day later after the Telangana High Court granted him interim bail for four weeks, expiring on January 10. On Friday, the Nampally court granted him regular bail, requiring him to furnish two sureties of ₹50,000 each. The court also directed him to appear before the investigating officer on Sunday. The stampede occurred when fans jostled to catch a glimpse of the actor, who arrived at Sandhya Theatre with music director Devi Sri Prasad for the premiere. Hyderabad Police later registered a case against Allu Arjun, his

security team, and the theatre management under sections 105 (culpable homicide not amounting to murder) and 118(1) (voluntarily causing hurt or grievous hurt by dangerous means) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

Police Commissioner C.V. Anand stated that the young boy likely suffered brain damage due to oxygen deprivation during the incident. The case has raised serious concerns about crowd management and the accountability of public figures during high-profile events.



Minister Narayana Directs Immediate Action on TDR Bonds TPN Correspondent

Amaravati, Jan 04

Minister Narayana has issued crucial orders to expedite the issuance of Transferable Development Rights (TDR) bonds, addressing long-standing delays and irregularities. During a video conference with municipal commissioners and urban development authority (UDA) officials, the minister instructed that all pending TDR bonds be issued to eligible beneficiaries by tonight, excluding those linked to irregularities from the previous government's tenure.

Key Highlights of the Meeting:

- Pending Bonds: A total of 437 TDR bonds from the previous government's tenure remain pending. Minister Narayana directed their issuance via the online system by tonight.
- Current Applications: Since the coalition government assumed office, 654 new applications for TDR bonds have been received. These are under review by respective municipalities, and the minister urged their issuance within two to three days.
- Irregularities: The minister highlighted massive irregularities in the issuance of TDR bonds during the previous administration. These cases were investigated by committees, resulting in the temporary suspension of bond issuance.
- Improved Processes: To prevent further delays and ensure transparency, the government resumed TDR bond issuance online. The minister emphasized prompt action to ensure no beneficiary faces unnecessary difficulties.

The video conference was attended by Secretary Kannababu, Director Harinarayanan, and Town Planning Director Vidyullatha, alongside municipal and UDA officials. Minister Narayana reaffirmed the government's commitment to accountability and timely resolution of public grievances, ensuring that eligible beneficiaries receive their dues without hindrance.



Jitwani Case

In a significant development in the high-profile Kadambari Jitwani case, it has come to light that IPS officers allegedly connected to the incident have been suspended. The case, involving the Mumbai actress, has taken a political turn, with accusations of ministerial intervention obstructing the course of justice.

Sources allege that an IPS officer from Chirala, facing allegations of misconduct in the Jitwani case, is attempting to evade accountability with the backing of a prominent Andhra Pradesh state minister. The officer, known for his controversial role during the YSR Congress Party (YCP) government, is accused of acting as a political enforcer rather than a law enforcement official. Reports suggest that he misused

his position to register false cases and harass individuals during the previous administration.

Allegations of Ministerial Support Political critics claim that the state minister in question is shielding the officer, influencing the investigation to stall progress. Despite the suspension of IPS officers linked to the case, no substantial investigation has reportedly been conducted against them. Observers allege that the minister's actions are creating a protective barrier for the officer, undermining the pursuit of justice.

The officer, who is currently out on anticipatory bail, is rumored to be lobbying ruling government ministers to neutralize the charges against him. This has raised concerns about the misuse of political influence to safeguard individuals in positions of power.

Govt to Issue Orders in Telugu Alongside English

The Andhra Pradesh government has taken a landmark decision to promote the Telugu language by mandating that government orders (GOs) be issued in both Telugu and English. The General Administration Department has formalized this directive through GO MS No. 3, issued in both languages.

This move recognizes the linguistic identity of Andhra Pradesh, where over 90% of the population speaks Telugu. Officials highlighted that making GOs available in Telugu would enhance public understanding and ensure greater accessibility. Key Aspects of the Policy:

- Bilingual Issuance:
- Departments may initially release GOs in English and upload the Telugu version within two days or vice versa.
- Alternatively, the orders can be issued simultaneously in both languages.
- **Translation Support:**
- Departments have been instructed to use the services of the Director of Translation to ensure accurate and reliable translations of GOs into Telugu.
- Implementation Guidelines:
- Principal Secretary S. Suresh Kumar has directed all departments to strictly adhere to this bilingual issuance policy.

The government highlighted that GOs play a pivotal role in governance and that issuing them in Telugu is vital for a state aiming to strengthen Telugu as its first language. This policy seeks to integrate the language deeply into administrative processes and governance.

Jagan Has Burdened the State With a Debt of ₹5 Lakh Crore - Minister Atchannaidu

Minister Atchannaidu launched a scathing attack on former Chief Minister Jaganmohan Reddy, accusing him of corrupting Andhra Pradesh and leaving the state in financial turmoil. Speaking to the media on Friday, Atchannaidu highlighted the alleged mismanagement of resources and heavy debts incurred during the YSRCP government's tenure.

"Jagan has burdened the state with a debt of ₹5 lakh crore in five years and is now paying ₹22,000 crore annually in interest alone," Atchannaidu alleged. He claimed the state is on "a ventilator" but has received "oxygen" due to the central government's cooperation in recent months.

He criticized the YSRCP for introducing the Land Titling Act, claiming it was an attempt to deceive the people, and assured that the TDP repealed the act to protect the public. Atchannaidu also highlighted the financial crisis under the YSRCP, stating the state's wealth was insufficient to pay employees' salaries.



Promising a brighter future, Atchannaidu said the TDP government would fulfill all its commitments, including providing ₹8,400 crore in benefits under its schemes. He assured support to fishermen, including ₹20,000 assistance during the fishing ban and development of coastal jetties to prevent migration. Atchannaidu criticized the YSRCP for failing to deliver any development, asserting, "There was zero progress under the YSRCP govern-

ment." He pledged that the TDP would bring ₹1.8 lakh crore in investments and create 20 lakh jobs within six months of taking power. Concluding his speech, Atchannaidu called on the people to cooperate with TDP's vision of growth, stating, "We will not see the ghost of Jagan again in the state." He praised MLA Buchibabu for his dedication to development despite personal financial losses in politics.

Complaint Filed Against BJP Leader Madhavi Latha Over Controversial Comments

Telugu Desam Party (TDP) Mala Corporation Director Konkari Kamalamma and Tadipatri TDP women councilors have filed a complaint at the Tadipatri town police station against BJP leader and actress Madhavi Latha. The complaint pertains to Madhavi Latha's

controversial remarks about the New Year's Eve programs held under the leadership of Municipal Chairman JC Prabhakar Reddy.

The special event, organized on December 31 in Tadipatri, was exclusively for women. However, Madhavi Latha allegedly made inappropriate comments, claiming there was rampant use of ganja in Tadipatri and advising women to avoid attending the program. Her remarks have sparked outrage among TDP leaders. Kamalamma strongly condemned Madhavi Latha's statements, questioning how someone residing in Karnataka could make such claims about Tadipatri without direct knowledge of the situation. She further



criticized Madhavi Latha for attempting to tarnish the reputation of the town and its leadership.

The TDP leaders have demanded that the police register a non-bailable case against Madhavi Latha. Kamalamma urged law enforcement to take strict action, asserting that such baseless and derogatory comments should not go unpunished.

The incident has added to the growing tensions between the TDP and BJP, as political leaders from both parties continue to exchange sharp criticisms. The Tadipatri police are yet to issue an official statement regarding the complaint.

Minister Satyakumar Slams JC Prabhakar Reddy Over 'Prostituted' Remarks

TPN Correspondent Vijayawada, Jan 04 Andhra Pradesh Minister and BJP leader Satyakumar lashed out at former TDP MLA JC Prabhakar Reddy for his controversial remarks and allegations, which have sparked tensions between the TDP and BJP.

The dispute began with New Year celebrations organized by JC Prabhakar Reddy in Tadipatri, which

included a special event for women. BJP leader and actress Madhavilatha criticized the event in a video, urging women not to attend and alleging that atrocities were occurring at JC Park. In response, JC Prabhakar Reddy made harsh comments, referring to Madhavilatha in derogatory terms and accusing her of being a "prostitute."

Amid these developments, buses belonging to Diwakar Travels, associated with JC, were set on fire. JC alleged that BJP leaders were responsible and went as far as to call them "less than Hijras."

Minister Satyakumar condemned JC's remarks, describing them as inappropriate and baseless. He stated that JC appeared to lack clarity on what he



was saying and noted that several allegations against JC's businesses had surfaced in the past. Satyakumar emphasized that such comments against BJP, a key ally in the political alliance, were unacceptable.

The minister advised JC Prabhakar Reddy to conduct himself with dignity and act according to his age. He reiterated the importance of maintaining decorum and mutual respect within the alliance, cautioning against behavior that could harm the partnership between the two parties.

The incident has deepened the rift between TDP and BJP leaders, raising questions about the stability of the alliance as both sides exchange sharp criticisms.

New Terminal Building at Vijayawada Airport to Be Completed by June

Illegal Collections from Small Traders in Gurajala Draw Flak



TPN Correspondent, Gurajala: Small traders in Gurajala town are raising concerns over alleged illegal money collections by members of the ruling coalition party. Reports indicate that these traders, primarily cart vendors, are being forced to pay amounts ranging from ₹5,000 to ₹10,000 per cart monthly, amounting to a collective extortion of ₹30,000 to ₹40,000.

The traders allege they face threats of eviction from their locations if they fail to comply with these demands. "If we had

the financial capacity to pay such rent, we wouldn't be operating from carts but from rented shops," lamented a victim. Under the previous government, the municipal department collected a nominal fee of ₹500 per cart per month, issuing proper receipts. However, traders say municipal authorities are no longer involved, and unauthorized leaders have taken over collections.

One female leader allegedly threatened vendors, demanding immediate compliance or face removal of their carts. Traders claim the names of prominent party leaders are being invoked to justify the collections, but they believe these leaders are unaware of the situation.

The affected traders are appealing to local MLA Yarapathineni Srinivasa Rao to address the issue and protect their livelihoods. "We urge the MLA to ensure justice and support small traders like us," they said.

Authorities have yet to respond to the allegations, but the traders' plight has sparked widespread discontent and calls for an investigation.

Vande Bharat Sleeper Train Achieves Peak Speed of 180 km/h During Trial Runs

Water Level in Glass Remains Static as **Train Reaches Milestone Speed**

The Vande Bharat Sleeper Train has achieved a significant milestone by reaching a peak speed of 180 km/h during its trial runs, which were conducted over the last three days. These trials are part of the ongoing process to evaluate the train for official certification by the Railway Safety Commissioner.

Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw shared a video on Friday showcasing the Vande Bharat sleeper train achieving the peak speed of 180 km/h during multiple trials. The trials are expected to continue until the end of the month.

One of the key moments in the trial was a 30-km-long run between Kota and Laban in Bundi district of Rajasthan on Thursday. In a video posted by the minister, the water level in a glass placed next to a mobile phone remained perfectly static despite the high speed of the train.

In addition to this, the Ministry of Railways reported that a 40-kmlong trial run between Rohal Khurd and Kota on January 1 saw the train reach 180 km/h. On the Kota-Nagda and Rohal Khurd-Chau Mahla sections, the train achieved speeds of 170 km/h and 160 km/h, respectively.

Trial Runs to Continue Until Month's End

The trials, supervised by the Research, Design & Standards Organization (RDSO) in Lucknow, will continue throughout January. Once completed, the Vande Bharat sleeper train will undergo a final evaluation by the Railway Safety Commissioner at its maximum speed. The official certification will follow, enabling the train to be inducted into regular service across the country.

Those Indulging In Politics Over My Apology Seek Unrest: CM Biren

Amid the continuing unrest in Manipur, Chief Minister N Biren Singh on Friday addressed the controversy surrounding his apology for the 20-month-long ethnic conflict in the state, accusing those politicizing his statement of seeking to prolong instability. Singh emphasized that his government's top priority is the restoration of peace in the region.

Singh urged all communities in Manipur to come together and work towards a permanent solution to the ethnic conflict that has rocked the state since May 2023. He urged people to "forgive and forget," stressing that the past should be left behind in order to build a peaceful future.

In his statement, Singh clarified that his apology was meant for the innocent victims and those who had lost their homes or loved ones during the violence. "What I said was an expression of sadness and grief," he explained, adding that it was not directed at those responsible for the violence. Singh rejected the idea of apologizing to terrorists, asserting that his words were intended to comfort the displaced and those who had suffered.

On Tuesday, Singh had publicly apologized for the ethnic conflict, which has resulted in over 250 deaths and left thousands displaced. His apology had stirred political debates, with some opposition parties accusing him of not doing enough to resolve the crisis. However, Singh rejected these claims, accusing the opposition of lacking an ideology and using the situation for political gains.

Ajay Kumar Bhalla Sworn in as the 19th **Governor of Manipur**

Bhalla's appointment as the Governor of Manipur was made by President Droupadi Murmu, and he replaces Assam Governor Lakshman Prasad Acharya, who had been handling the additional charge of Manipur. Bhalla's appointment is seen as a significant move by the government, given his extensive administrative experience at the national level.

Two men set on fire over **Union Carbide waste** disposal at Pithampur

During the protest against the dumping of contaminated garbage, two men poured petrol on themselves while sloganeering. Amidst the crowd, someone allegedly lit them on fire, leading to the self-immolation incident. The incident occurred on Friday amidst a bandh (shutdown) called by local groups opposing the incineration of the hazardous waste in the industrial town.

During the protest, which was held against the planned incineration of the waste, eyewitnesses said the two men, both in their 40s, poured petrol on themselves and set themselves ablaze. A person in the crowd allegedly lit them on fire, as captured in a video filmed at the scene. The protesters had been chanting slogans against the disposal of the contaminated garbage when the self-immolation occurred.

Both men were rushed to a hospital in Pithampur, located around 30 km from Indore, and later transferred to a private hospital in Indore. Fortunately, they were reported to be out of danger. Dhar Superintendent of Police Manoj Singh confirmed that the situation was under control but remained tense. Protests also continued in other parts of the town.

Bandh and Protests in Pithampur

Shops and markets in Pithampur remained closed as part of the bandh call by the Pithampur Bachao Samiti, a local group that claims the incineration of Union Carbide waste poses a significant threat to the health and environment of the local community. Pithampur, an industrial town with a population of around 1.75 lakh, hosts nearly 700 factories across three sectors.





2,700 Cops vs. Hundreds of Yoon **Supporters in 6-Hour Standoff**

Bid to Arrest Impeached South Korean President Fails

SOUTH KOREA: Anti-corruption investigators attempting to arrest impeached South Korean President Yoon Suk Yeol were blocked by his security team and hundreds of supporters, leading to a dramatic six-hour standoff. The attempt to apprehend Yoon, who faces charges related to a controversial martial law declaration in early December, ended after authorities withdrew over safety concerns.

On Thursday, about 2,700 police officers surrounded Yoon's residence in a bid to arrest the ousted president, who could face imprisonment or even the death penalty if convicted. However, Yoon's security team, supported by nearly a thousand of his supporters, prevented the investigators from gaining access to his residence. The standoff lasted until 1:30 pm, when authorities called off the operation.

This confrontation followed the imposition of martial law in early December, which had a profound impact on South Korea, rattling financial markets, damaging the local currency, and disrupting diplomatic relations. Yoon was suspended from his official duties in mid-December, with Prime Minister Han Duck-soo stepping in briefly before being impeached as well. Despite his suspension, Yoon remains defiant and has vowed to fight in court to retain his position. The attempted arrest marked



the first-ever such move against a sitting South Korean president. China's Mega Dam Project in **Tibet Raises Environmental** and Geopolitical Concerns



NEW DELHI: Last week, China revealed plans to construct the world's largest dam in Tibet, surpassing even the Three Gorges Dam. The project, situated in the environmentally-sensitive Himalayan region near the India-Tibet border, has raised alarms not only due to its potential environmental impact but also its geopolitical ramifications. The proposed dam will be built on the Brahmaputra River, which China refers to as the Yarlung Tsangpo in Tibet.

China's ambitious dam project is expected to generate 300 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity annually, significantly more than the Three Gorges Dam's 88.2 billion kWh capacity. At an estimated cost of USD 137 billion, the project will be the largest hydropower initiative in the world, surpassing any other infrastructure project globally. However, the scale and location of the project have raised concerns in India.

The dam's construction site is located in a highly seismic zone, which makes the region prone to earthquakes. The fragile geology of the area, combined with the potential environmental risks, has led to significant apprehension in India. With Tibet's proximity to India's northeastern states, especially Arunachal Pradesh and Assam, the effects of the project could be far-reaching. The dam could disrupt the flow of the Brahmaputra River, creating severe floods and droughts in the region, putting millions of people at risk downstream.

India has responded firmly, asserting its rights to the river's waters. The Ministry of External Affairs stated that New Delhi would continue to monitor developments closely and take necessary steps to safeguard its interests. It has called on Beijing to ensure that the project does not harm downstream countries, particularly India.

The environmental impact of the project could extend beyond the river itself. Large-scale hydropower projects like this one tend to alter ecosystems and agricultural landscapes, potentially causing irreversible damage to the region's biodiversity and disrupting the livelihoods of communities dependent on the river. Furthermore, the project raises the specter of forced resettlements, as seen with the Three Gorges Dam, which displaced over 1.4 million people. China has not yet disclosed how many individuals will be displaced by this new mega-project, but the scale of the dam suggests the number could be substantial.

Geopolitically, the dam could exacerbate tensions between India and China. As both nations are downstream users of the Brahmaputra's waters, the project has the potential to fuel "water wars" in the future, a concern previously highlighted by geopolitical analyst Genevieve Donnellon-May. India's long-standing fears about Chinese control over water resources may now be heightened, as the construction of this dam could shift the balance of power in the region.

The approval allows a professional-level delegation composed of experts from Israel's Mossad (intelligence agency), the IDF (military), and the ISA (internal security agency) to keep engaging in indirect negotiations. These talks, which are being facilitated by Qatar, Egypt, and the United States, have been ongoing in Doha, Qatar's capital.

Trump Blasts Biden as "Worst President" Over New Orleans Terror Attack

WHITEHOUSE: President-elect Donald Trump strongly criticized Joe Biden on Friday, calling him the "worst president" in U.S. history and blaming the current administration for the recent terror attack in New Orleans. Trump accused Biden of exacerbating America's security problems through his "Open Borders Policy," claiming it has led to an increase in violent crimes, including terrorism.

In a post on X (formerly Twitter), Trump stated that he had repeatedly warned that radical Islamic terrorism and violent crime would escalate under Biden's policies. He claimed that the situation has now reached a crisis point, far worse than he had ever imagined. Trump emphasized his belief that Biden's leadership has turned the U.S. into a "disaster" and made the country a "laughing stock" on the global stage.

Trump's criticism also extended to federal agencies, accusing them of focusing on "unlawfully attacking their political opponents" rather than ensuring the safety and security of American citizens. He expressed outrage over what he sees as the infiltration of radical elements within government institutions, warning that national security and democracy are being undermined.

The Republican leader also placed blame on



the Democratic Party, urging Democrats to feel "ashamed" for allowing what he considers a decline in American safety and values. He called for the CIA to take immediate action to address the threats facing the country, fearing it could be too late if swift measures are not taken.

Trump closed his remarks with a call for strong leadership, asserting that only through decisive action can America reverse the decline he claims is taking place. He ended with his signature slogan, "Make America Great Again," signaling his readiness to confront what he describes as a national crisis once he assumes office on January 20th.

China declares State of Emergency on new virus HMPV outbreak

CHINA: China is grappling with a new wave of respiratory infections, particularly a rapid spread of Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV), five years after the COVID-19 pandemic. HMPV, which typically causes coldlike symptoms such as coughing, wheezing, runny nose, and sore throat, has raised concerns across the country. The virus, though not as severe as COVID-19, has contributed to a significant uptick in hospital admissions and overwhelmed healthcare systems.

Social media posts and local reports indicate that China has seen multiple outbreaks of HMPV in recent weeks, leading to overcrowding in hospitals. In some areas, the pressure on medical facilities is so intense that people are finding it increasingly difficult to access timely care. In addition to HMPV, the country is also dealing with a surge in cases of Influenza A, Mycoplasma pneumoniae, and a resurgence of COVID-19, further exacerbating the strain on the healthcare system.

Hospitals, which are already overwhelmed, are being forced to cope with an increasing influx of patients. The situation is similarly dire at crematoriums, which are reporting a surge in demand for services, as more people succumb to these viral infections. The simultaneous circulation of multiple viruses has



put China's public health infrastructure under considerable stress, raising concerns about its ability to handle a simultaneous outbreak of so many diseases.

The rapid spread of HMPV, in particular, highlights the ongoing vulnerabilities in China's healthcare system, even as the country continues to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. Health experts have called for heightened vigilance and preventive measures to curb the spread of these viruses and to ensure that the healthcare system can cope with the current crisis. With the winter season intensifying the transmission of respiratory viruses, China's medical and emergency response teams are facing an unprecedented challenge.





Stock Markets Plunge in a Day of Turmoil

Heavy Losses Across IT, Pharma, and Banking Sectors

Domestic stock markets witnessed a turbulent session on Friday, closing with significant losses as a mix of domestic and global factors weighed heavily on investor sentiment. Mixed signals from Asian markets, profit booking, and high domestic valuations were compounded by foreign institutional investor (FII) outflows, a weak rupee, and fears of a global economic slowdown. Uncertainty surrounding US trade policies under Trump further contributed to the bearish mood. The IT, pharma,

and banking sectors experienced sharp declines, while some resilience was observed with the Nifty closing at 24,004.

The BSE Sensex started at 80,072 but faced intense selling pressure, dipping to an intraday low of 79,109 before closing at 79,223, down 720 points. Similarly, the NSE Nifty began at 24,196, touched

a low of 23,976, and ended the day at 24,004, down 183 points. The Bank Nifty followed suit, falling 616 points to close at 50,988. Broader market activity showed nearly equal participation from buyers and sellers, with 1,470 stocks advancing and 1,349 declining out of 2,903 traded Stanley assigning an equal-weight rating to Petron the NSE.

Sectoral performance was mixed, with gains in Avenue Super Mart with a target price of ₹5,360, FMCG, Media, PSU Bank, Consumer Durables, and Oil & Gas indices, while Bank, Finance, IT, Pharma, Realty, and Healthcare indices dragged the market lower. Among Nifty50 constituents, ONGC, Tata Motors, SBI Life, Titan, and Nestle India emerged as top gainers, while Wipro, HDFC Bank, Adani Ports, Tech Mahindra, and Cipla recorded the steepest losses.

The rupee settled at 85.78 against the US dollar, adding to investor concerns. Notably, 88 stocks hit 52-week highs, while only 15 touched 52-week

Brokerage recommendations included Morgan onet LNG, CLSA giving an outperform rating to and Nomura issuing buy ratings for Dixon Tech and Voltas. Meanwhile, SEBI issued a warning to JM Financial over IPO-related merchant banking issues.

Despite the steep losses, analysts remain cautiously optimistic, citing strong fundamentals in specific sectors that could offer stability in the near term. However, they advise investors to tread carefully given the prevailing global uncertainties.

Textile Industry Raises Concerns Over Quality Control Order (QCO) and Its Impact on Jobs

The Confederation of Indian Textile Industry (CITI) has raised alarms over the Quality Control Order (QCO) on key input materials, stating that it is harming jobs and stifling growth in the domestic textile sector. In its pre-Budget memorandum to the Finance Ministry, CITI emphasized that the QCO, which blocks the import and sale of materials lacking a Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) mark, is diminishing the competitiveness of the downstream indus-

try. It is also creating a significant barrier to accessing essential raw materials.

According to CITI, the BIS certification process is particularly challenging for micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs), which are crucial players in the textile industry. The complex and time-consuming process is discouraging these smaller businesses from obtaining the certification, leaving them unable to import essential materials. Moreover, CITI argued that the QCO is inadvertently contributing to the creation of monopolies in the market, with large businesses benefiting from stronger lobbying power and easier access to resources.

The textile body pointed out that countries like Bangladesh and Vietnam do not face such restrictions, allowing their industries



to freely access raw materials without any non-tariff barriers (NTBs). In contrast, India's imposition of the QCO on man-made fibre (MMF) and yarn has created an artificial trade barrier, hindering the free flow of these critical inputs. This has resulted in shortages of specialized fibre and yarn varieties, which, in turn, has driven up domestic prices, putting additional strain on the industry.

CITI stressed that the QCO is negatively affecting the textile sector's ability to meet growing demand, particularly for products that require specific, high-quality raw materials. By limiting access to these inputs, the QCO is damaging the overall competitiveness of the Indian textile industry, harming both large and small businesses, and ultimately leading to job losses in the sector.

India's Palm Oil Imports Drop to Nine-Month Low as Prices Surge



Global Food Prices Dip in December, Sugar Leads Decline

The United Nations' world food price index experienced a modest decline in December, largely driven by a drop in sugar prices, according to the latest data from the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO). The index fell to 127.0 points, down from 127.6 in November. However, it still marked a 6.7% increase compared to the same month in 2023, although it remained significantly lower—by 20.7%—than the record high reached in March 2022.



Tndia's palm oil imports fell Isharply in December, reaching a nine-month low as prices surged to a 2-1/2-year high. The increase in palm oil prices led refiners to shift their focus to alternative oils, such as soyoil, which was available at a discount. According to five dealers, this shift in purchasing patterns significantly impacted India's palm oil import numbers.

Palm oil imports dropped by 40% in December compared to the previous month, amounting to just 503,000 metric tons. This marks the lowest import volume since March 2023, signaling a significant change in demand from the world's largest buyer of vegetable oils.

The decline in palm oil imports could have a ripple effect on the global market. While it may put downward pressure on benchmark Malaysian palm oil prices, it could provide support for U.S. soyoil futures. As Indian refiners turn to cheaper substitutes, the demand for soyoil is likely to rise, potentially influencing the global supply and pricing of vegetable oils.

The shift in India's import behavior reflects broader trends in the vegetable oil market, where fluctuations in prices and the availability of alternative oils can significantly impact purchasing decisions. With soyoil now being favored due to its price advantage, refiners are adapting to market conditions in an effort to manage costs while continuing to meet domestic demand for vegetable oils.

The drop in palm oil imports may also have longer-term implications for global vegetable oil markets, as India's purchasing decisions often serve as a bellwether for other countries. As India continues to navigate price volatility and changing demand patterns, the palm oil market may experience further adjustments in the months ahead.

Sugar prices led the decline in December, dropping by 5.1% month-on-month. This decrease was attributed to improved sugarcane crop forecasts in major producing nations, which helped ease concerns over supply shortages. Despite this drop, sugar prices were still 10.6% lower than their level in December 2023, reflecting a softening trend in the global market.

Dairy prices also experienced a downturn after seven consecutive months of increases. In December, dairy prices fell by 0.7% from November, although they still posted a significant yearon-year gain of 17%. Meanwhile, vegetable oil prices dropped by 0.5% month-on-month, but remained up by 33.5% compared to December 2023, driven by strong demand and production challenges in key oilseed markets.

The FAO's monthly food price index is a key indicator for tracking global food commodity prices. While the December dip offers some relief, the broader trend still reflects a tight global food supply, especially for products like dairy and vegetable oils. As the world moves into 2025, fluctuations in crop yields, international trade dynamics, and inflationary pressures will continue to influence food prices, with sugar and other key commodities at the forefront of these developments.

RBI Likely to Cut Policy Rates by 50 Basis Points in 2025, Says Report

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is expected to reduce policy rates by 50 basis points (bps) in the first half of 2025, according to a report by Jefferies. This anticipated rate cut follows the central bank's recent shift in its monetary policy stance, where it eased liquidity measures and cut the Cash Reserve Ratio (CRR) by 50 bps during the latest Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting.

The Jefferies report suggests that after easing its approach to liquidity and reducing the CRR, the RBI may review its policy rates, with a projected

50 bps cut in the first half of 2025. This marks a significant development in the central bank's ongoing efforts to maintain economic stability.

The report emphasizes that the RBI's shift



from a "withdrawal" stance to a "neutral" liquidity position, along with the CRR reduction to 4 percent of Net Demand and Time Liabilities (NDTL)—a level last seen before the COVID-19 pandemic—paves the way for potential policy rate cuts. This

change in the liquidity position is seen as an important factor in the RBI's broader strategy to support economic growth and investment.

If the rate cut materializes, it is expected to have a stabilizing effect on regulatory momentum, fostering a more conducive environment for growth and investment. With the central bank's approach becoming more accommodating, businesses and investors may benefit from the more favorable monetary policy, helping to bolster economic activity in the near term.

As the RBI continues to adjust its policy in response to evolving economic conditions, market participants and analysts will closely monitor any further moves that could influence the pace of India's economic recovery.









More generally, as we age, many people report that time seems to accelerate. 
