

As per the court's orders, the actor must report to the investigating officer every Sunday between 10 am and 1 pm for two months or until the charge sheet is filed.

The court also imposed conditions barring the actor from changing his residential address without informing the court and prohibited him from leaving the country without approval. These conditions will remain in effect until the case is resolved.

On Sunday morning, Ram Gopal Peta police served notices at Arjun's residence in Jubilee



Hills, advising him not to visit Sree Tej, the son of the woman who died in the stampede, at KIMS Hospital. Despite this, Arjun complied with his bail conditions and appeared at the Chikkadapalli police station, where he signed the register and left after a brief stay. In light of his visit, the police had arranged heavy security around the station.

# **Home Minister Anitha** Blames YCP Govt for Issues in Visakhapatnam Central Jail

Visakhapatnam, Jan 06

State Home Minister Vangalapudi Anitha visited Visakhapatnam Central Jail on Sunday morning and attributed the ongoing issues to the failures of the previous government. Highlighting concerns about prisoner safety, she emphasized the need for immediate corrective measures and strict monitoring.

During her visit, the Home Minister inspected areas where contraband, including cell phones, was recently discovered. She confirmed that a detailed investigation is underway, and strict action will be taken against those responsible. Anitha also revealed allegations of can-

nabis supply within the jail, adding that a marijuana plant was shockingly found on the premises. She warned that negligence by staff will not be tolerated, and disciplinary measures, including transfers, would follow based on the findings of the investigation.

The minister criticized the absence of proper records of visits to the jail over the past five years and questioned the lax security protocols during the previous administration. She announced plans to modernize the facility by installing CCTV cameras within ten days to enhance surveillance. Additionally, some prisoners are being transferred from Visakhapatnam Central Jail to Rajahmundry Jail to address security concerns.

Jail Superintendent Mahesh Babu has intensified in-



spections, with officials conducting thorough searches across all blocks over the past four days. These inspections have led to the seizure of three cell phones, a cell battery, and two data cables. Earlier, two cell phones, a battery, and data cables were recovered from Hemant Kumar, an accused in the kidnapping case involving a former MP's family.

Anitha assured that the investigation into the cell phone case will conclude within 10-15 days, and staffing levels in the jail will be increased. She reaffirmed the government's commitment to using technology and strict governance to prevent such incidents in the future, ensuring the safety and security of all prisoners.



Sriram expressed his frustration over the increasing trend of films that he believes insult Hinduism. He highlighted several instances where Hindu deities and religious symbols were misrepresented or distorted. One such example he shared was when a music director refused to use the term "Brahmanda Nayakudu," prompting Sriram to stop working with him.

The lyricist emphasized that films that belittle Hindu beliefs should be boycotted, stressing the harmful impact these movies have on society. He particularly criticized the way Hindu gods and myths were being reinterpreted and portrayed in an inaccurate manner. According to Sriram, such films should not be accepted by the public. Sriram also took issue with the portrayal of historical figures in films, especially the character of Karna in the movie Kalki 2898 AD. He questioned how the film could depict Karna as greater than Arjuna and Dharmaraja, who remained silent during the episode of Draupadi's cheerharan. Sriram argued that such portrayals were contrary to Hindu dharma, which would not condone these fabricated interpretations.

Furthermore, Sriram lamented that these distortions were not limited to Kalki alone, but were seen in various adaptations of Indian mythology across films. # Teachers in AP Yet to Receive Salaries, Says Venkatrami Reddy

TPN Correspondent, Amaravati: Venkatrami Reddy has raised serious concerns over the delay in disbursing salaries to teachers in Andhra Pradesh. Expressing anger, he stated that salaries, which should have been paid on January 1 to mark the new year, remain pending, causing financial distress to the teachers.

Venkatrami Reddy criticized the coalition government for failing to fulfill promises made to government employees. "Not a single promise has

He further alleged that the government is disrespecting employees by forcing village and ward secretariat staff to distribute pensions in the early hours of the morning, often under challenging and embarrassing circumstances, especially for women employees.

Venkatrami Reddy also highlighted unfulfilled commitments such as the introduction of interim relief (IR) and the delay in forming a PRC (Pay Revision Commission). "After announcing PRC, at least a commission should have been formed, but there has been no progress," he said.

The situation has led to widespread discontent among government employees and educators, who are demanding immediate action from the government to address their grievances and ensure timely payments moving forward.

### Turaka Kishore Arrested in Attack Case on TDP Leaders Buddha Venkanna and Bonda Uma

Interestingly, although Turaka Kishore was arrested earlier in this case during the previous government's tenure, he was granted station bail within a day, raising questions about the handling of the case.

The arrest marks a significant development as the current government intensifies efforts to hold individuals accountable for past political violence. Further investigations are underway, with the police expected to bring more clarity to the case in the coming days.

## **Solar Missions in 2025: Unlocking the Sun's Mysteries**



Heliophysics enters a transformative phase with new missions, strategic plans, and insights into solar activity during an active cycle.

Heliophysics is set to make significant progress in 2025 with the Sun's increasing activity, new solar missions, and a strategic research plan for the decade. These efforts aim to deepen understanding of the Sun's behavior, its effects on Earth, and its influence across the solar system.

As Solar Cycle 25 reaches its peak, the Sun's activity is at its most intense phase. This cycle, part of an 11-year pattern, has already produced numerous solar flares and coronal mass ejections. While not breaking historical records, Solar Cycle 25 has offered invaluable data, collected through advanced solar telescopes and spacecraft making record-setting approaches. These observations are driving research into how solar phenomena impact our planet, satellites, and the broader solar system. In 2025, six major heliophysics missions are slated for launch, promising groundbreaking discoveries. One of the key missions is the Interstellar Mapping and Acceleration Probe (IMAP), which will map the Sun's outer influence, known as the heliosphere. This mission will provide crucial insights into how solar winds interact with interstellar space. Another significant project is the Escape and Plasma Acceleration and Dynamics Explorers (ESCAPADE), a dual-spacecraft mission that will study space weather around Mars, improving our understanding of the Red Planet's atmosphere and its interaction with solar winds.

The Polarimeter to Unify the Corona and Heliosphere (PUNCH) mission will examine the Sun's outer atmosphere using four small satellites. It will focus on the dynamic relationship between the corona and solar wind, helping researchers understand how energy and particles travel through space. These missions, along with others launching this year, will expand the scope of solar research and address long-standing questions about the Sun's activity and its far-reaching effects.

A recently released decadal report on heliophysics outlines strategic goals for the next ten years. Among the proposed initiatives is a mission deploying more than 26 spacecraft to study Earth's magnetic field and auroral phenomena, offering new insights into space weather and its effects on the planet. Another ambitious project aims to explore the Sun's poles over an entire solar cycle, a region critical for understanding the Sun's magnetic field and its role in driving solar activity.

Supporting these missions will be the Next Generation Global Oscillations Network Group (ngGONG), an advanced initiative to enhance solar interior studies. This technology will provide unprecedented detail on solar oscillations, helping scientists unlock key mysteries about the Sun's inner processes.

The importance of these missions cannot be overstated. The Sun's activity has a profound impact on life on Earth, from affecting communication systems to influencing climate patterns. Solar flares and coronal mass ejections can disrupt satellites, power grids, and navigation systems. Understanding the Sun's behavior is crucial for predicting and mitigating the effects of space weather events. Heliophysics research also has implications beyond Earth.

# PM Modi Urges Delhi to Elect BJP for Development, Calls AAP Rule a 'Disaster'

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, addressing a massive rally in Rohini on Sunday, launched a sharp critique of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government in Delhi, terming its ten-year rule an "AAP-da" (disaster). Modi urged citizens to vote for the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in the upcoming 2025 Assembly elections, promising a transformative era of development for the national capital.

"I appeal to the people of Delhi to give BJP a chance and let Delhi progress," said the Prime Minister, emphasizing the party's vision to make Delhi a worldclass capital as India aims to become the third-largest economic power globally. The rally, branded as a 'Parivartan rally,' follows Modi's recent address in Ashok Vihar, where he inaugurated key infrastructure projects. On Sunday, he laid the foundation stone for several projects worth over ₹12,200 crore, including the 13-km stretch of the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut Namo Bharat corridor and the 2.8-km Delhi Metro Phase-IV stretch between Janakpuri and Krishna Park. He also announced the 26.5-km Rithala-Kundli section of Metro Phase-IV and a new Central Ayurveda Research Institute in Rohini.



Highlighting BJP's developmental achievements, Modi stated, "Delhi needs a double-engine government—BJP at both the Centre and the state—to ensure seamless progress. Most of the development in Delhi, including Metro expansions, highways, and PM Awas Yojana housing projects, has been done by the Central government."

Slamming the AAP administration, Modi accused it of lacking vision and pushing

Delhi into stagnation. "In ten years, this government has delivered no progress. Delhi needs development, and the people trust BJP to make that happen," he remarked, reiterating his commitment to urban transformation.

With infrastructure upgrades and development initiatives underlined as key priorities, Modi's rally set a decisive tone for the BJP's campaign in the 2025 Delhi Assembly elections.



# Coast Guard Chopper Crash in Gujarat's Porbandar Claims Three Lives

An Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) of the Indian Coast Guard tragically crashed in Gujarat's Porbandar on Sunday, resulting in the deaths of three crew members. The chopper, which burst into flames upon impact, was on a routine sortie when the incident occurred.

The crash took place at the Air Enclave of the Indian Coast Guard. Several people were injured and are currently receiving treatment at the civil hospital. The identities of the victims have not yet been disclosed, and an inquiry has been initiated to determine the cause of the crash.

Repeated Incidents Raise Concerns This incident is the latest in a series of accidents involving the ALH Dhruv helicopters operated by India's armed forces. Four months ago, in September, an ALH MK-III helicopter fell into the Arabian Sea off Porbandar, leading to the deaths of three crew members. The body of the pilot in command, Rakesh Kumar Rana, was recovered in October after a month-long search.

Two years ago, design and metallurgy flaws were identified in the ALH Dhruv fleet, prompting a safety audit. Despite corrective measures and technical checks across the 325 ALH Dhruv helicopters operated by the Indian Navy, Air Force, Army, and Coast Guard, these recurring crashes raise questions about the platform's reliability.

The Coast Guard, which operates as a maritime law enforcement and search-and-rescue agency, has often relied on the ALH Dhruv for critical missions. However, this latest accident underscores the need for further scrutiny and enhanced safety measures for the fleet. Further details regarding the crash and the victims are awaited as investigations continue.



# UK-based NRI Divorces Wife via Triple Talaq on Video Call

Mumbai Police launch investigation after woman alleges harassment and demands for dowry in the complaint.

In a disturbing incident, a UK-based Indian man allegedly divorced his wife via triple talaq during a video call. The victim, who has now filed a complaint with Mumbai Police, has accused her husband of harassment and dowry demands. Police have initiated a case under the Muslim Women (Protection of Marriage Rights) Bill and the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

According to the complaint, the woman, married to Aaqib Bhatiwala in 2022, was initially living a normal married life. However, after relocating to the UK with her in-laws, the victim claims that the situation deteriorated, and she faced increasing harassment. The conflict reportedly escalated after a domestic dispute, during which her husband confiscated her jewelry, sent her back to India, and cut off communication.

The victim claims that she was divorced through triple talaq during a video call after returning to India. She also alleged that she was later denied entry into her husband's home upon her return to the UK.

Mumbai police have begun investigating the case, as triple talaq is illegal in India under the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Act, 2019, following a Supreme Court ruling in 2017 which declared the practice unconstitutional.

# Over 160 Flights Disrupted, Train Delays as Dense Fog Blankets Delhi-NCR

A thick blanket of fog engulfed Delhi and the surrounding regions on Sunday morning, causing significant disruptions to air and rail travel. For the third straight day, reduced visibility severely affected operations, leaving passengers stranded and schedules in disarray.

At the Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA), over 160 flights were impacted. More than 155 flights faced delays, primarily those without advanced CAT III navigation systems, while at least eight were cancelled. By 7:30 am, visibility had dropped to zero. Despite assur-



ances from the Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) that operations were ongoing, passengers were warned of delays for non-CAT III-compliant flights. Rail services also faced disruptions, with over 50 trains delayed by an average of four to six hours. The Railways urged

passengers to verify train statuses before travel as visibility across the city plummeted.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) issued an alert, warning of dense fog during the morning hours. Saturday marked the season's longest zero-visibility spell in Delhi, with Safdarjung weather station recording eight hours of complete fog cover. Temperatures ranged slightly above

average, with the maximum at 20°C and the minimum at 7.8°C.

Adding to the discomfort, the city's air quality remained in the 'very poor' category. The Central Pollution Control Board reported an AQI of 377, a level posing health risks to vulnerable groups.

## Nitish Kumar's "Mistake" Reply To Lalu Yadav's "Doors Open" Comment"

Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar has firmly dismissed Opposition leader Lalu Prasad Yadav's recent remarks about keeping "doors open" for political reconciliation. Speaking to reporters during a visit to Muzaffarpur, Kumar made it clear there is no possibility of rekindling ties with Lalu Yadav's Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD), stating, "I had by mistake ('galti se') aligned with them a couple of times."

Nitish Kumar's Janata Dal (United) [JD(U)] was once part of the Grand Alliance led by the RJD but later exited due to differences and joined the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA). The Chief Minister highlighted his dissatisfaction with past partnerships, asserting that his government has achieved significant progress compared to previous administrations.

"Back then, people feared stepping out of their homes after sunset. Women's empowerment, such as the self-help groups we initiated under the Jivika scheme, was unheard of. The Centre later adopted our model as Ajivika. Such confident rural women were not seen before," Kumar remarked, emphasizing his government's achievements. Lalu Yadav's Cryptic Offer

Lalu Prasad Yadav had recently extended an olive branch, saying, "Our doors are open," sparking speculation about potential political maneuvering. However, Kumar's categorical rejection underscores the deep rift between the two leaders.

This exchange comes in the backdrop of Union Home Minister Amit Shah projecting Nitish Kumar as the NDA's chief ministerial candidate for the upcoming Bihar Assembly elections. BJP leaders have echoed similar sentiments, reaffirming Kumar as the face of their alliance in Bihar. The BJP, which fell short of a majority in the recent Lok Sabha elections, continues to rely on allies like JD(U) and Chandrababu Naidu's TDP for support at the Centre.

# Bengaluru Techie Atul Subhash's Wife, In-Laws Get Bail In Abetment Of Suicide Case

The wife and in-laws of Bengaluru techie Atul Subhash, who tragically died by suicide on December 9, have been granted bail by a Bengaluru court in the abetment of suicide case. Subhash had alleged harassment by his wife Nikita Singhania and her family members, which he claimed drove him to take his own life.

Subhash's wife Nikita, along with her mother Nisha Singhania and brother Anurag Singhania, had earlier approached the session court for bail. Following directions from the Karnataka High Court, the session court expedited the hearing and granted bail today.

On December 14, Nikita was arrested in Gurugram, while Nisha and Anurag were apprehended in Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh.

Subhash, aged 34, left behind a distressing video and a 24-page suicide note in which he detailed the marital issues, harassment, and extortion attempts by his wife, her family, and an Uttar Pradesh-based judge. He accused his wife and her relatives of pushing him to suicide through false cases and consistent torture. Subhash also alleged that his wife demanded Rs 3 crore to resolve the issue.

Subhash and Nikita married in 2019 and had a son in 2020. The deceased's parents have sought custody of their four-year-old grandson, expressing concerns over his whereabouts.

Pawan Kumar, Subhash's father, stated, "My son was broken from inside... Even after torture by his wife and in-laws, he didn't tell anyone about it. His suicide note also mentioned that his parents be given custody of his child."

The family is awaiting a January 7 hearing in the Supreme Court regarding the child's custody. Pawan Kumar also alleged that his daughter-in-law had treated the child as an "ATM," extorting money from him. Meanwhile, Atul Subhash's counsel, Akash Jindal, argued that the accused should not be permitted to use the child as leverage in securing bail, adding that the family has already filed a habeas corpus petition before the Supreme Court regarding the child's whereabouts. The case continues to draw attention to the tragic circumstances surrounding Subhash's death and the allegations against his wife and her family.



# **How Expensive Was the Diamond PM Modi Gifted US First Lady Jill Biden?**

#### ₹17 lakh or less than ₹2 lakh

During his visit to the United States in June 2023, Prime Minister Narendra Modi presented a 7.5-carat lab-grown diamond to US First Lady Jill Biden, sparking a debate over its valuation. US authorities valued the diamond at \$20,000, making it the most expensive gift given to the Biden family by a world leader. However, the Indian Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) suggested a much lower value, estimating the diamond at less than ₹2 lakh.

According to sources quoted by the Times of India, the 7.5-carat diamond was grown in a lab, which makes it significantly cheaper than a natural diamond. Labgrown diamonds typically range between ₹15,000 and ₹25,000 per carat, which means the diamond's value would fall between ₹1.1 lakh and ₹1.9 lakh. The higher valuation by the US State Department is believed to have been based on the cost of natural diamonds, which are far more expensive.

The diamond was presented by at the White House, as part of his state visit. In addition to the diamond, PM Modi also gifted US President Joe Biden a carved san-



dalwood box, a book titled The Ten Principal Upanishads, a statue, and an oil lamp. American authorities valued these gifts at approximately \$6,232.

The gifts from PM Modi were transferred to the National Archives and Records Administration, while the diamond was re-PM Modi during a private dinner tained "for official use" in the East Wing of the White House.

ufacturing. The process mimics the natural conditions under which diamonds form beneath the earth's surface. Smit Patel, convenor of the Gem & Jewellery Export Promotion Council (GJEPC), explained that the diamond symbolized India's 75 years of independence. He also highlighted that the diamond was made using green energy, aligning with PM Modi's vision of promoting renewable and sustainable energy sources in India.

## "Travesty": Elon Musk Criticizes **Biden for Honoring George Soros**

Elon Musk has publicly criticized U.S. President Joe Biden's decision to award billionaire philanthropist George Soros the Presidential Medal of Freedom, calling it a "travesty" in a post on X (formerly Twitter).

Soros, a billionaire investor and founder of the Open Society Foundations, was among 19 recipients of this year's award, which recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to American society. The White House cited Soros for his efforts in advancing democracy, human rights, education, and social justice.

Soros' recognition has sparked intense debate, highlighting the polarizing figure's role as a major donor to Democratic causes. Republicans, including Musk, have labeled the award politically motivated. In contrast, Biden defended the decision, stating that the recipients reflect "values that define America."

"These nineteen individuals are great leaders who have made extraordinary contributions to our country and the world," Biden said during the announcement.

Other notable honorees include former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton, football icon Lionel Messi, and actors Michael J. Fox and Denzel Washington.

In the U.S., Republicans have consistently criticized Soros for leveraging his wealth to influence policy and elections. Musk's comments reflect this broader skepticism, adding another layer of political polarization to an already contentious decision.

The debate over Soros' Medal of Freedom underscores the enduring divisions in American politics, where philanthropy and political activism often intertwine with controversy.

# New Zealand Eases Visa Rules, Benefiting Indian Workers?

In a significant move to address severe labour shortages and streamline immigration processes, New Zealand has introduced updated visa policies that will likely benefit Indian workers and migrants from other countries. These changes will make it easier for skilled professionals to find employment opportunities in the country, as well as provide more flexible options for lower-skilled workers.

The most notable change involves a reduction in the work experience requirement for applicants. Previously, applicants needed a minimum of three years of work experience; this has now been reduced to two years, easing access for

many qualified individuals. Additionally, two more stable employment opportunities. new visa pathways have been introduced for In a further positive change, the New Zealand seasonal workers. These include a three-year multi-entry visa for experienced workers and a seven-month single-entry visa for lower-skilled workers. This is expected to address New Zealand's immediate need for seasonal labour while providing better visa options for foreign workers.

For workers falling under the Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations (ANZSCO) skill levels 4 or 5, the validity of their work visas has been extended from two to three years. This extension allows workers to stay longer in the country and benefit from

government has removed the median pay requirement for the Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV) and Specific Purpose Work Visa (SPWV). While employers will still need to post job opportunities and offer salaries reflecting market rates for the role and location, they are no longer required to meet a predetermined salary threshold. 

## **India's Petroleum Product Demand Expected to Rise** by 3-4% in FY25



Tndia's demand for petroleum **⊥**products, including petrol, diesel, and LPG, is projected to increase by 3-4% in the current financial year ending March 31, 2025, according to a Fitch Ratings report. This growth is fueled by rising consumer demand, along with increased industrial and infrastructure activity.

However, the report also predicts that refinery margins for India's oil marketing companies (OMCs) will fall below their mid-cycle levels in FY25. This decline is attributed to factors such as lower product cracks, regional oversupply, and reduced benefits from price differences between crude varieties. Despite this, marketing margins are expected to remain higher than FY24, thanks to lower Brent crude oil prices, which should help mitigate the pressures from lower refining mar-

For upstream companies like

Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) and Oil India Limited (OIL), the report forecasts a dip in profits due to subdued production and lower crude oil prices. Domestic prices for gas produced from old fields are expected to remain capped at \$6.5/MMBTU in the second half of FY25, determined by a formula pegged to 10% of crude prices.

India's crude oil production is projected to decline by 2-3% in FY25, as upstream companies face challenges in offsetting natural output declines from ageing fields. However, production is expected to see modest growth in FY26, driven by increased output from ONGC's eastern offshore KG Basin and privately owned fields. The country's crude oil import dependency is expected to rise, as demand for petroleum products outpaces the growth in domestic crude oil production.

Foxconn's Q4 revenue represented a 15.2% year-on-year increase, surpassing the LSEG SmartEstimate of T\$2.1 trillion. This growth was primarily driven by the strong market demand for cloud and networking products, reflecting the growing need for AI server technology.

The company's smart consumer electronics segment, which includes iPhones, remained steady year-on-year, indicating robust performance despite a challenging global market. However, AI server sales significantly contributed to the overall rise in revenue, with total revenues for December alone surging by 42.3% YoY to T\$654.8 billion, marking its second-highest level ever for the month.

Foxconn noted that the first quarter of 2025 typically marks the off-season for its operations. Despite this, the com-

## **OYO Revises Check-in Guidelines:** Relationship Proof Required for Couples

 ${f N}$ ew rules prohibit unmarried couples from checking in at OYO partner hotels in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. OYO has introduced a major change in its check-in policy, now requiring couples to provide valid proof of relationship before being allowed to check in at partner hotels in Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. This new guideline prohibits unmarried couples from booking rooms together. The policy, effective immediately, will apply to both online and in-person bookings at OYO hotels in the city.

According to the revised guidelines, partner hotels will have the discretion to accept or decline bookings based on local social sensibilities. The company stated that this decision came in response to feedback from civil society groups in Meerut, which had urged for such action, along with

similar petitions from residents in other

OYO emphasized that the move is part of a broader initiative to position itself as a brand that prioritizes safe experiences for families, students, business, and solo travelers. The company also aims to promote longer stays and repeat bookings as part of this new direction.

Additionally, OYO is undertaking nationwide efforts to ensure safe hospitality



practices, including blacklisting hotels that allegedly promote immoral activities and taking action against unauthorized establishments using OYO branding. Pawas Sharma, Region Head of OYO North India, clarified that while OYO respects individual freedoms, it must also collaborate with local law enforcement and civil society groups in the areas where it operates. The policy will be periodically reviewed to assess its impact.

## **Panipuri Vendor Gets GST Notice After Earning Rs 40 Lakh, Internet Divided**

Apani puri vendor from Tam-li Nadu has sparked controversy after receiving a GST notice for reportedly earning Rs 40 lakh in online payments during the 2023-24 financial year. The vendor was summoned under Section 70 of the Tamil Nadu Goods and Services Tax Act and the Central GST Act on December 17, 2024.

According to GST regulations, any business with an annual turnover exceeding Rs 40 lakh is required to register and comply with taxation rules. The notice, which has since gone viral on


social media, asked the vendor to appear in person and submit financial documents covering his transactions over the past three years. The authorities aim to review the vendor's earnings, particularly focusing on the significant digital payments received during the last financial year.

The notice also emphasized that failing to obtain GST registration after crossing the Rs 40 lakh turnover threshold constitutes an offence.

The internet's reaction to the GST notice has been mixed. One user commented, "40 L is the amount he received and that may or may not be his income. You have to deduct ingredients, manpower costs, fixed expenses, etc. He may be earning just enough to get by." Another user stated, "I believe more than 50 per-

cent of people would be paying in cash as the payments are not hefty, merely 50-100 bucks. He must

Some commenters criticized the potential impact of the tax notice on small vendors. One said, "The taxman's action would push people into cash transactions!" Another pointed out that the vendor could face tough competition due to the added GST, making his bills higher than competitors who do not charge GST. The issue also sparked conversation due to a viral video from a comedian, who argued that operating a pani puri stall could be more profitable than a corporate job. He emphasized that vendors enjoy a steady stream of customers and flexible working hours, highlighting the potential of the food business.

# "Temperament Is Key": Gambhir on India's Batting Woes

The importance of domestic cricket and grinding through tough moments cannot be overstated, says Gambhir.

Former Indian cricketer Gautam Gambhir has attributed India's recent Test struggles to a lack of temperament and inadequate participation in domestic cricket. Speaking at a press conference after India's 1-3 series defeat to Australia in the Border-Gavaskar Trophy, Gambhir emphasized the need for players to prioritize redball domestic tournaments like the Ranji Trophy to hone their skills and strengthen the Test side.

"I would always like everyone to play domestic cricket. That

to play domestic cricket. That is how much importance domestic cricket needs to be given," Gambhir stated. He pointed to India's repeated batting failures, with sub-200 scores in six of nine innings during the series, as a sign of deeper issues that cannot be resolved without commitment to the domestic circuit. India's batting woes have persisted both at home and overseas, a trend Gambhir attributed to temperament. "Test cricket is all about playing the session, seeing off tough spells, and converting starts into big hundreds," he said. Gambhir called for a collective focus on grinding through challenging moments, especially in a format that demands resilience. He further highlighted the low participation of India's top players in domestic cricket. Stars like Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma have not featured in the Ranji Trophy for years,



which Gambhir believes has impacted their ability to finetune their red-ball game.

India's senior players, including Rohit Sharma and Virat Kohli, struggled throughout the series. While Rohit missed the final Test due to poor form, Kohli's vulnerability outside the off-stump led to eight dismissals in the series. Gambhir refrained from commenting on their future in Test cricket, instead stressing that it is up to the players to assess their hunger and contribution to the

team's success.

"It's about whether the team is moving forward with your contribution or not. The Indian team is bigger than any individual," he remarked.

Despite the series loss, Gambhir noted several positives for India, particularly from the younger players like Yashasvi Jaiswal, Nitish Reddy, and Washington Sundar. He also praised Mohammed Siraj's commitment, calling it "outstanding" for his relentless efforts despite not always being fully fit.

Gambhir emphasized a holistic approach to improvement across all departments, stating, "If we want to improve and do better, we need to address issues in batting, bowling, and fielding. Blaming one department alone won't help."


