#### Police Arrest YSRCP MP Avinash Reddy's **PA Raghav Reddy Over Obscene Social Media Posts**

Police have arrested Raghav Reddy, the personal assistant (PA) of YSRCP MP Avinash Reddy, in connection with obscene social media posts targeting prominent political figures including Chandrababu Naidu, Pawan Kalyan, Nara Lokesh, and Anitha. Raghav Reddy was arrested at his residence in Pulivendula after the Andhra Pradesh High Court rejected his anticipatory bail petition.

The allegations against Raghav Reddy stem from his involvement in posting offensive content online, in collaboration with YSRCP social media activist Varra Ravindra Reddy. The posts have sparked controversy and public outrage. Furthermore, Raghav Reddy is reportedly an accused in a case under the SC/ST atrocity laws, which adds to the gravity of the charges against him.

Following the news of his arrest, a large group of YSRCP activists gathered at the Pulivendula police station in solidarity, underscoring the political tensions surrounding the case. The police took Raghav Reddy into custody after his bail plea was denied, and he is now being detained for further investigation.

### **ACB Raids: Formula E Car Race Case Leads to Searches in Andhra Pradesh**

The Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) intensified its investigation into the Formula E Car Race case, which has already created a stir in Telangana. Following a recent verdict by the Telangana High Court, ACB officials launched extensive searches across the Telugu states, including Andhra Pradesh.

On Tuesday, ACB teams conducted raids in Machilipatnam, AP, as part of the probe, seizing several key documents. The officials also inspected the office of

Ace Urban Developers, where they reportedly took printers and made copies of critical documents. A team of 12 senior ACB officials carried out the operation, focusing on tracing the source of funds related to the car race. According to sources, the ACB is questioning employees and collecting detailed financial records to uncover the money trail. It was revealed that Greenco, a company linked to Chalamasetty Sunil, is under scrutiny. Sunil, whose birthplace is Machilipatnam in Krishna district, has ties to the case. His mother, Venkatalakshmi,

previously served as the chairman of the Bandar Municipal Corporation. The raids come amid allegations that funds from questionable sources may have been used in the Formula E Car Race. Telangana ACB officials, under direct orders from higher authorities, have been conducting simultaneous raids in Hyderabad and other locations. The ACB's investigation is expected to uncover more details about the financial and operational irregularities surrounding the race, as officials continue their aggressive pursuit of evidence.

The program will offer specialized training in areas such as Electrical, Mechanical, Blade Technology, Material Management, Operations & Maintenance, and Land & Liasoning. It is set to run over the next four years and will create a future-ready workforce for the renewable energy sector in India. Suzlon will also establish a curriculum for ITIs, polytechnics, and engineering colleges, collaborating with universities to integrate globally recognized content.

The MoU was signed as a tribute to the late Shri Tulsi Tanti, the visionary founder of Suzlon, who was committed to enhancing Andhra Pradesh's role in the renewable energy sector. "This pro-



gram will help bridge the skill gap and create green jobs, contributing to the development of Andhra Pradesh and strengthening India's position in the renewable energy industry," said Nara Lokesh, Minister for IT & Human Resources Development.

JP Chalasani, CEO of Suzlon Group, shared that the initiative reflects Shri Tanti's dream of establishing a renewable energy university in India. "With this program, we aim to make Andhra Pradesh a talent hub for the renewable energy sector," he added.

The program will feature 'Learning Labs' at five strategic locations in Andhra Pradesh, offering a mix of classroom learning and hands-on training. The centers will also focus on job placement, further amplifying the program's impact in developing a sustainable workforce for India's future.

### Minister Kandula Durgesh Assures East Godavari Farmers of Sufficient Urea Supply

State Tourism, Culture, and Cinematography Minister Kandula Durgesh has taken proactive measures to ensure there is no urea shortage for farmers in East Godavari district. Minister Durgesh instructed the Agriculture Department officials to take all necessary steps to avoid any disruptions in the supply of urea to the region, particularly in the 18 mandals facing potential shortages.

The Agriculture Department has clarified that there is no shortage of urea in the district. They confirmed that 2,500 metric tons of urea are ready for supply by January 10, with a total of 69,000 tons of various fertilizers already distributed for the Rabi season. Of this, 30,000 metric tons of urea have been supplied. In addition to urea, 300 tons of DAP and 150



tons of urea were distributed on the day of the announcement.

Despite misinformation being spread about fertilizer shortages, officials assured the public that the district has ample stock. However, some societies that have not cleared payments are temporarily on hold. The department emphasized the importance of using urea in combination with complex fertilizers. While urea is essential, excessive use can cause soil erosion and salinity, which negatively affects future yields. Combining urea with complex fertilizers, on the other hand, will improve crop health and yield, benefiting farmers in the long term.

Minister Durgesh's assurances have provided much-needed relief to farmers in the region, as they continue to work toward a successful harvest in the Rabi season.

# **APSRTC Announces Special Buses for Sankranti Festival with No Extra Charges**

In a festive announcement, the Andhra Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation (APSRTC) has made arrangements for 7,200 additional buses to help passengers travel home for the Sankranti festival. This move is aimed at accommodating people from Andhra Pradesh living in different states, including Telangana and Karnataka, who wish to return to their hometowns for the celebrations.

The special bus services will run from January 8 to 13, with a special focus on major cities like Hyderabad, Bengaluru,

and Vijayawada. APSRTC has revealed that 3,900 buses will be dedicated to this service, including 300 buses from Vijayawada, 2,153 from Hyderabad, and 375 from Bengaluru. The corporation has also made a sweet announcement: no additional charges will be levied for these special buses, making travel more affordable during this busy festival period. Furthermore, APSRTC is offering a 10 percent discount for passengers booking round-trip tickets simultaneously, encouraging early reservations. In addition, the corporation will run 3,200 buses from January 16 to 20 to facilitate the return journey after the festival.

Sankranti is one of the most signifi-

cant festivals in the Telugu states, and as thousands of people travel to their hometowns, there is usually a shortage of buses. Despite arrangements made by both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana governments each year, the rush often results in difficulties for passengers. This time, however, the increased number of buses is expected to ease the travel burden and ensure smoother journeys for those celebrating the festival.

The Telangana state government has also announced that 6,432 special buses will be operated to various areas, further supporting the transportation needs of the people during this peak travel period.

### Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu Assures Irrigation Department Officials of Promotion Relief

Water Resources Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu has promised to address the concerns of irrigation department officials regarding the long-standing issue of promotions. During a meeting with members of the Irrigation Engineers Association at his camp office in Vijayawada on Tuesday, Ramanaidu assured that he would take the matter to Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu for resolution.

The irrigation department officials expressed their frustration over the lack of promotions during the previous government, which had caused significant distress among employees. In response, Minister Ramanaidu acknowledged that public service workers across various departments had faced hardships due to the previous government's policies. He assured the officials that he would bring their concerns to the attention of the Chief Minister to facilitate the resolution of these issues. Minister Ramanaidu also expressed his dissatisfaction with the previous government's approach, pointing out that while welfare programs were prioritized, the state's development had been neglected. He emphasized that infrastructure, industries, and employment opportunities had been left behind under the previous administration. He also noted that industries, including the Lulu company, had moved to neighboring states due to the lack of support in Andhra Pradesh.

With the alliance government now in power, Ramanaidu outlined the steps being taken to revive the state's development, including the rapid progress of the Polavaram project and the work towards the completion of the capital city of Amaravati. He assured that under the leadership of Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, the alliance government would prioritize development and resolve the challenges faced by state employees, including irrigation officials.

### Former Minister Perni Nani Gets Minor Relief in Rice Theft Case

**High Court Orders Adjournment**

Former Minister and YSRCP leader Perni Nani received some relief in the anticipatory bail petition filed in connection with the high-profile rice theft case in Andhra Pradesh. The Andhra Pradesh High Court adjourned the hearing on his petition until January 20, issuing a crucial directive to the police not to take any hasty action until the next hearing

Perni Nani, who is named as A6 in the case, was allegedly involved in the sale of ration rice in Machilipatnam, Krishna district. His wife, Jayasudha, is identified as A1, with the godown in her name. While Jayasudha has been linked to the incident from the start, Perni Nani was included as A6 later. Upon learning of this, he filed an anticipatory bail petition seeking protection. The court heard arguments from both parties and decided to defer the case, instructing the police to hold off on any immediate decisions until the adjourned hearing on January 20.

In related developments, the Machilipatnam District Court ordered the one-day police custody of key accused in the case, including A2 Manas Tej, and lorry drivers A4 Mangarao and A5 Anjaneyulu. These individuals are being interrogated regarding the rice theft operation, with police

hoping to uncover more details about the conspiracy. The investigation suggests that the accused acted on instructions from Perni Nani. Authorities are probing further into the network involved, including the transport and sale of the stolen rice, with the possibility of adding more charges against Perni Nani depending on the findings. The case continues to be under investigation, with police working to uncover the full extent of the scam.

### PM Modi's Visit to Visakhapatnam: Key **Insights from MP Daggubati Purandeswari**

Visakhapatnam, Jan 08 Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Visakhapatnam on Wednesday, Janu-

ary 8, marking his first visit to Andhra Pradesh after the coalition government assumed office. During this visit, he will lay the foundation stone for several development landmark projects aimed at boosting the state's progress.

State BJP President and MP Daggubati Purandeswari, while inspecting arrangements at the Andhra University Engineering College grounds along with Minister Nadendla Manohar, described the visit as a transformative step for Andhra Pradesh. She highlighted that Prime Minister Modi

would initiate projects focused on green energy, infrastructure, and industrial growth.

Among the key initiatives, the Prime Minister will lay the foundation stone for India's first Green Hydrogen Hub at Pudimadaka near Visakhapatnam under the National Green Hydrogen Mission. This project, along with the NTPC Green Energy Limited initiative, represents a



significant investment of ₹1.85 lakh crore. Additionally, Modi will inaugurate and launch various railway and road projects worth ₹19,500 crore, including the foundation stone for the Visakhapatnam South Coast Railway Zone headquarters.

Purandeswari also shared that the central government plans to establish a new steel plant in Visakhapatnam, with Union Steel Minister HD Kumaraswamy working on a supportive package and resolving salary issues.

Responding to the recent attack on the Telangana BJP office in Hyderabad, Purandeswari condemned the incident, urging the Telangana government to

identify the culprits and take action. She called such attacks regrettable in a democratic setup.

With security tightened and traffic diversions in place, Visakhapatnam is ready to host the Prime Minister's visit, which promises to bring significant advancements in infrastructure and energy sectors for Andhra Pradesh.

### Case Registered Against YSRCP Leader Kakani Govardhan Reddy

A case has been registered against former minister and YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) leader Kakani Govardhan Reddy at the Vedayapalem police station in Nellore district. The complaint was filed on the 27th of last month, but details of the case have surfaced only recently.

The case pertains to allegations that Kakani, who is also the Nellore district YSRCP president, attempted to intimidate police officials to obstruct an

investigation. The allegations claim he pressured officials to weaken the case filed against his associate, Mandala Venkata Seshaiah, a former ZPTC member from Venkatachalam.

Seshaiah has been accused of sexually harassing a woman from Venkatachalam mandal. Following the complaint, the court remanded Seshaiah into custody.

Reacting to the developments, Kakani Govardhan Reddy issued a stern warning, stating that if the YSRCP regains power, Venkatachalam CI Subbarao would be made to "take off his khaki uniform and wear a green shirt." He

also issued threats directed at TDP leaders N. Chandrababu Naidu and Nara Lokesh, claiming they would face consequences.

Meanwhile, a separate complaint has been lodged against Kakani, accusing him of threatening police officers and officials in an attempt to influence the investigation into the case.

These incidents have sparked significant controversy, with political opponents accusing the YSRCP of misuse of power and attempts to shield their members from accountability. The investigation into both cases is ongoing.

#### Vidadala Rajini Slams **Government Over Neglect** of Arogyasri Services

Former minister and YS-RCP leader Vidadala Rajini has criticized the coalition government for its alleged negligence towards the healthcare of the poor. She expressed concern that the delay in paying dues under



the Arogyasri scheme has led to a suspension of services in network hospitals, causing significant distress among the public.

Rajini emphasized that the Arogyasri scheme, introduced by former Chief Minister YS Rajasekhara Reddy, has been a lifeline for the underprivileged. She praised Former Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy for further strengthening the program after assuming office in 2019. "Under Jagan's leadership, old Arogyasri dues amounting to ₹637 crores were cleared," she noted.

However, Rajini accused the current coalition government of neglecting the Arogyasri Trust and failing to pay ₹3,000 crores owed to hospitals under the scheme. She claimed that hospitals have been forced to stop offering Arogyasri services due to the non-payment of dues, leaving the poor to suffer without access to essential medical care.

"The government is acting as if it is not responsible for the health of the people," she said, urging immediate action. Rajini demanded that the pending dues be cleared promptly to ensure the restoration of Arogyasri services and alleviate the burden on those relying on the scheme for healthcare.

Her statements come amid mounting criticism of the government's handling of healthcare initiatives, with opposition leaders accusing it of failing to prioritize the welfare of the poor.

### **Bail Denied to Former** MP Nandigam Suresh in Mariamma Murder Case

Delhi, Jan 08 The Supreme Court has denied bail

to former MP and YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) leader Nandigam Suresh in the Mariamma murder case, a high-profile incident that shook the Telugu states. The bench, headed by Justice Dipankar Dutta, dismissed Suresh's petition on Tuesday, stating it would not interfere with the orders of the trial court.

Nandigam Suresh was arrested and jailed for his alleged involvement in the 2020 murder of Mariamma, a Scheduled Caste woman from Velagapudi in Thullur Mandal. The

Court upheld this decision, stressing that it would not compromise the trial court's findings.

Mariamma, who had publicly accused YS Jagan Mohan Reddy of reneging on promises to provide her with a house and pension, was murdered in 2020. She had alleged that her pension was stopped and that the promises made to her were not fulfilled.

# **Major Ganja Transporting** Operation in NTR Dist Police Seize Drugs, Hunt for Fugitives

In a significant operation that has left the police and public alike stunned, Nandigama police, under the leadership of ACP Tilak, thwarted an attempt to transport a large batch of ganja, sending shockwaves through the region. This crackdown is part of the coalition government's continued efforts to rid Andhra Pradesh of illegal drug trade, particularly ganja, which flourished during the previous YSRCP rule.

The NTR district police were tipped off on Tuesday morning that a batch of ganja was being transported through Nandigama. Acting swiftly, ACP Tilak alerted all police personnel and initiated a series of intense search operations across the constituency. Information surfaced that the ganja was being transported in a car traveling from Vijayawada. With the vehicle's whereabouts traced to the Keesara toll plaza, the police mounted a focused search along the

When the car was spotted near the Nandigama bypass, the suspects abandoned the vehicle and fled upon seeing the police. In a dramatic turn of events, the police seized

the abandoned car, which was found to be laden with ganja. Further investigation revealed that the car had been part of a larger trafficking operation. In another incident, on the same day, the police intercepted a separate vehicle carrying ganja near Gauravaram in Jaggayyapet mandal. While the police successfully seized the drugs, the accused managed to escape. To track down the fugitives, authorities deployed drones for extensive surveillance and





search operations, focusing on the missing individ-

The crackdown comes after Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu's clear directive to the police to eradicate drug trafficking in the state. The operation is seen as a significant step in the ongoing war against ganja suppliers and illegal drug trade in Andhra Pradesh.

## **HMPV Outbreak in India: No Need for Panic, Experts Advise**



Reports of an outbreak of an epidemic caused by the human metapneumovirus (HMPV) in India have sparked concerns, especially given the memories of the Covid-19 pandemic. The first cases of HMPV have been detected in Bengaluru, Ahmedabad, and Chennai, raising alarms about a potential respiratory disease crisis. Photos and videos from China showing people wearing masks in hospitals and other public spaces have only fueled these fears, drawing comparisons to the Covid-19 outbreak.

While the rise in cases has drawn attention, experts have repeatedly emphasized that there is no cause for panic. HMPV, a respiratory virus, was first identified in 2001, and much of its characteristics are already well-understood by the medical community. The virus primarily affects children under five years old, as well as the elderly and individuals with weakened immune systems. However, health authorities have reassured the public that it is not a new virus and that its symptoms are typically similar to those of other common respiratory infections like the flu or common cold.

India's Union Health Ministry has issued a statement confirming that the cases were detected through routine surveillance efforts by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), which regularly monitors respiratory illnesses. The Ministry has reported no significant increase in respiratory disease cases across the country, highlighting that the nation is well-equipped to handle such infections. Moreover, the children who tested positive for HMPV have no history of international travel, which further suggests that the virus is not being imported from other regions, but is circulating locally.

Karnataka's Health Minister, Dinesh Gundu Rao, clarified that the authorities are yet to determine whether this development should be classified as a serious public health concern, and whether additional measures, such as widespread PCR testing, will be needed. He assured the public that further investigations are underway, but for now, the situation remains under control.

## The Kejriwal Splurge: House **Renovation Scandal Threatens AAP's Image**



For once, the BJP and Congress are united in their the city was experiencing severe economic and criticism of former Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader is facing intense scrutiny after a Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) report revealed that he spent at least Rs 33 crore on the renovation of his official residence. This figure is more than four times the initial estimate of Rs 7.91 crore, a stark contrast to what was projected. The renovations were carried out in 2022, during the height of the Covid-19 pandemic, when the Delhi government was supposed to be prioritizing public health and safety.

This expensive and controversial renovation has created a public relations nightmare for Kejriwal, undermining his carefully cultivated image as a man of the people. The cost of certain items, such as Rs 96 lakh for curtains and Rs 66.9 lakh for marble stone, has sparked outrage, especially when the city was grappling with the pandemic and countless people were suffering. Kejriwal, who presented himself as the 'common man' CM, now faces significant questions about his leadership and priorities. The optics are especially damning, as they come at a time when

social challenges.

The CAG report has also highlighted several irregularities, notably in the remodeling of the ground-floor accommodation and the addition of a new floor to the residence. These findings raise concerns about the role of the Public Works Department and its possible complicity in the extravagant spending. A thorough and impartial investigation is necessary to uncover the full scope of the mismanagement and corruption involved.

This scandal has turned into a major issue in Delhi's upcoming Assembly elections, damaging AAP's credibility just as the party was hoping for a third consecutive term. The BJP and Congress are using the renovation controversy to weaken AAP's standing with voters, and the fallout could be significant. The party, which received a massive mandate in the 2015 and 2020 elections, will now have to work hard to rebuild the trust of Delhi's electorate. Kejriwal's image as a champion of the common man has taken a hit, and it remains to be seen how AAP responds to the mounting criticism.

# 2025: A Critical Year for NDA's Unity



The year 2025 will be a pivotal one for the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA), testing its cohesion and ability to navigate the complex dynamics of India's political landscape. The NDA, which was formed in May 1998, has endured many political shifts over the years. These concerns will need to be addressed carefully, as the BJP prepares for elections in Delhi and Bihar later this year. The results in these states could have a far-reaching impact on the NDA's ability to present a united front, both in state governance and in national politics.

While the BJP's strong leadership under Prime Minister Narendra Modi has played a key role in the NDA's sustained relevance, the party must ensure that its allies feel respected and empowered within the coalition framework. The challenge lies in balancing the aspirations of regional allies with the central leadership's vision.

As the NDA gears up for 2025, the unity of this alliance will be tested. The outcome of the Delhi and Bihar elections will likely serve as a critical indicator of the BJP's ability to maintain a strong and harmonious coalition ahead of future national elec-





# "We Will Definitely Win": Arvind Kejriwal As Delhi Election Dates Announced

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) national convenor and former Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal expressed confidence in the party's victory in the upcoming Delhi Assembly elections, set to be held on February 5, with the counting of votes scheduled for February 8. In a message on X (formerly Twitter), Kejriwal emphasized that AAP workers were gearing up for the polls with full strength and enthusiasm. He highlighted that the upcoming election would center around a contrast between the "politics of work" and the "politics of abuse," asserting that the people of Delhi would choose AAP's work-oriented politics.

Delhi Minister Gopal Rai added to this sentiment, noting that the party had completed all its preparations for the election. He mentioned that AAP's candidates for all 70 assembly constituencies had been announced and that the party was fully ready to contest the elections. Rai expressed optimism about the AAP returning to power, stating that the people of Delhi were eagerly awaiting the chance to elect Arvind Kejriwal's government again.

AAP leader Priyanka Kakkar echoed similar sentiments, emphasizing the party's consistent engagement with the people. She expressed confidence in the public's continued support, believing that the blessings of God and the people of Delhi would remain with the party.



On the other hand, BJP's Parvesh Verma, a candidate from the New Delhi assembly seat, congratulated the people of Delhi and the Election Commission of India (ECI) for marking the "festival of democracy." Verma, who is contesting against Kejriwal, criticized the AAP over allegations regarding the Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs), claiming that the opposition parties were preparing for defeat. He also asserted that the BJP would form the next government in Delhi.

The deadline for filing nominations for the elections is January 17, with the scrutiny of nominations scheduled for January 18 and the last date for withdrawal set for January 20. As the Model Code of Conduct has come into effect in Delhi, all political activities will be conducted under the guidelines until the conclusion of the election process.

With the announcement of election dates, the final voter list has been published, recording 1,55,24,858 registered voters in Delhi. The upcoming election promises to be a critical contest, with AAP aiming to maintain its dominance following its landslide victory in 2020, where it secured 62 out of 70 seats.

# Delhi to vote on February 5; counting on February 8

The Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) Rajiv Kumar announced on Tuesday that the polling for the 2025 Delhi Assembly elections will take place on February 5, with vote counting scheduled for February 8. This will be a single-phase election for all 70 assembly seats in the capital.

Along with Delhi, bypolls will also be held on the same day for two assembly constituencies—Milkipur in Uttar Pradesh and Erode in Tamil Nadu. However, bypolls for the Budgam and Nagrota constituencies in Jammu and Kashmir have been postponed due to snowy conditions. These elections will be conducted at a later date, with a deadline to complete the process before April.

The final date for filing nominations is January 17, followed by scrutiny of nominations on January 18. Candidates will have the option to withdraw their nominations by January 20. CEC Kumar noted that the election is scheduled for a Wednesday to encourage higher voter turnout, similar to the approach taken in Maharashtra.

Out of the 70 assembly seats in Delhi, 58 are general, while 12 are reserved. According to the latest electoral roll, the total number of voters in Delhi is 1.55 crore, which includes 83.49 lakh men, 71.74 lakh women, and 1,261 transgender individuals. Additionally, there are 25.89 lakh young voters,



2.08 lakh first-time voters, and 830 voters aged above 100 years.

Over 13,000 polling stations will be set up across the city to ensure smooth conduct of the elections. In the 2020 Delhi Assembly elections, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) secured 62 seats, while the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) won 8, and the Congress failed to win any seats.

Kumar further mentioned that bypolls were also pending in the Basirhat constituency of West Bengal and Visavadar in Gujarat due to ongoing election petitions. These bypolls cannot be held until the respective petitions are resolved in the state high courts.

### Amit Shah Launches Bharatpol For International Police Assistance

Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched the Bharatpol portal on Tuesday, a platform developed by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to enhance real-time information sharing among Indian law enforcement agencies and facilitate quicker access to international police assistance.

Describing the portal as a transformative step in tackling transnational crimes, Shah emphasized its role in elevating international investigations to new heights. "This initiative allows every investigation agency and state police force to easily connect with Interpol and expedite their investigations," he said.

Previously, the CBI coordinated international cooperation in criminal matters through various agencies, including law enforcement bodies. This coordination was primarily managed by INTERPOL Liaison Officers (ILOs) at the Central, State, and Union Territory levels. These ILOs were connected to Unit Officers (UOs) within local police forces, such as Superintendents of Police and Police Commissioners. However, communication among these entities relied on traditional methods like letters, emails, and faxes.

With the rise of transnational crimes, the need for rapid and real-time international assistance has become crucial. To address this, the CBI developed the Bharatpol portal, which integrates all stakeholders into a common platform. Accessible through the CBI's official website, the portal is set to significantly improve coordination and efficiency in criminal investigations.

# "Microsoft To Invest \$3 Billion In India For Cloud And AI Expansion"

Microsoft CEO Satya Nadella announced on Tuesday that the company will invest USD 3 billion (approximately Rs 25,700 crore) to expand its cloud computing and artificial intelligence (AI) capabilities in India. This marks the largest expansion in India by the tech giant. As part of its commitment, Microsoft also plans to train 10 million people in AI skills across the country by 2030.

Nadella made the announcement at a conference attended by startup founders and technology executives in India, a nation that is quickly becoming a major hub for AI innovation. His visit is part of a broader trend, as other tech giants such as Nvidia, AMD, and Meta have also recently visited India to explore AI opportunities.

The \$3 billion investment will be directed towards enhancing Microsoft's Azure cloud infrastructure in India. Nadella highlighted the company's existing presence with multiple Azure regions across India, including Central India, South India, and West India. Microsoft has built significant infrastructure in collaboration with Jio, contributing to its regional expansion.



In a previous visit to India in February 2024, Nadella had already announced plans to provide AI training for 2 million people by 2025, focusing on individuals in smaller cities and rural areas. This latest initiative will build on that commitment, expanding AI skilling opportunities to a broader base.

Nadella emphasized that India's role in AI innovation is rapidly growing, and Microsoft's investments in infrastructure and education will ensure that people and organizations across the nation are equipped to benefit from this technology.

#### India Confirms 7 HMPV Cases; Health Ministry Assures No Cause for Concern

India has reported seven cases of Human Metapneumovirus (HMPV), a respiratory virus that has recently garnered attention due to an outbreak in China. The Indian government has reassured the public that there is no cause for panic, as the virus is already in global circulation and the country is well-equipped to manage any potential rise in respiratory illnesses.

Two new cases of HMPV have been reported in Nagpur, Maharashtra. Both patients have recovered and been discharged, according to a private lab that released the details. Samples have been sent to AIIMS virology for further analysis.

The first two cases of HMPV in India were reported in Bengaluru, Karnataka, on Monday. One case involved a three-month-old baby, who has been discharged, while the other, an eightmonth-old, is still under recovery at a hospital. A third case was confirmed in Ahmedabad, Gujarat, in a two-month-old infant who was admitted with symptoms of cold, cough, and breathing difficulty. The child is recovering and is ready for discharge.

Tamil Nadu reported two cases on Monday—one in Chennai and the other in Salem. No deaths have been reported from HMPV in India. The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) emphasized that HMPV is not unusual in India and has been circulating globally.



### **Justin Trudeau Resigns as Canadian Prime Minister Amid Party Turmoil**

After months of speculation, Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced his resignation as both the Prime Minister and leader of the Liberal Party on Monday. The decision followed the resignation of his once-trusted Deputy Prime Minister, Chrystia Freeland, last month. Her departure sparked renewed calls for Trudeau's resignation, not only from opposition leaders but also from several Liberal MPs.

Trudeau's resignation marks a significant turning point for Canada as it navigates internal political challenges and global issues. Meeting with Governor General Mary Simon, Trudeau recommended proroguing Parliament until March 24 to allow for the selection of a new leader. In his statement, Trudeau emphasized the need for fresh leadership, stating, "This country deserves a real choice in the next election."

Acknowledging the difficulties within his party, Trudeau explained, "If I am having to fight internal battles, I cannot be the best option in that election." He confirmed that he would step down as party leader and Prime Minister after a competitive leadership process is completed by the Liberal Party.



In an emotional address, Trudeau reflected on his tenure, saying, "Since 2015, I've fought for this country and for you." ### Imran Khan cannot be tried for failing to deposit gift in Toshakhana: Pak IHC

In a significant legal development, the Islamabad High Court (IHC) ruled that former Prime Minister Imran Khan cannot be prosecuted for failing to deposit a Bulgari jewellery set, as per the Toshakhana rules, under the amended 2023 regulations. The court's ruling clarified that the revised rules could not be applied retroactively and emphasized that under the original 2018 rules, the only requirement was the submission of a receipt for the gift, not its deposit.

The case stemmed from the Federal Investigation Agency's (FIA) accusations against Khan and his wife, Bushra Bibi, alleging that they undervalued the Bulgari jewellery set, which was gifted by the Saudi crown prince. The FIA claimed that the undervaluation resulted in a loss of Rs 32.8 million to the national exchequer.

Justice Miangul Hassan Aurangzeb, delivering the 14-page judgment, clarified that the amendments made to the Toshakhana rules in 2023, which introduced penalties for failing to submit gifts to the state treasury, were not applicable to the time when the gift was received. He pointed out that the 2018 rules only mandated the submission of a receipt, not the gift itself.



were no allegations of direct threats or coercion regarding the undervaluation of the jewellery, and the defense argued that Khan had adhered to the 2018 rules by submitting the necessary receipt. No evidence was presented to dispute this claim.

Justice Aurangzeb also highlighted the significant delays in the trial,

The court further noted that there remarking that despite Khan's detention for over four months, he had not been formally indicted, adding to the concerns of judicial inefficiency in the case.

### **China Closes Mount Everest Scenic Areas After 6.8-Magnitude Earthquake**

China has temporarily closed the scenic areas of Mount Everest, also known as Mount Qomolangma, to tourists following a powerful 6.8-magnitude earthquake that struck Dingri County in the Tibet Autonomous Region on Tuesday. The earthquake occurred at 9:05 am Beijing Time and rattled the region, which is home to the base camp of the world's highest peak.

Local authorities reported that both staff members and tour-

ists in the area were safe following the tremor. However, the earthquake caused significant damage to the surrounding areas, with 53 people confirmed dead and 62 others injured, according to the regional disaster relief headquarters. Despite the devastation, the hotel buildings and the surrounding scenic area infrastructure were reportedly intact, as per a statement from the Dingri Culture and Tourism Bureau.

The Qomolangma Station for Atmospheric and Environmental Research, situated in Dingri, experienced a power outage, though it was confirmed that the research station's facilities were still in good condition. The region, located at the China-Nepal border, experienc-



es extreme temperatures, with recent weather forecasts indicating a temperature range between minus 18°C and zero.

In 2024, the Chinese side of Mount Qomolangma saw a surge in tourism, with 13,764 overseas visitors, more than double the number recorded in 2023. Tourists from countries such as Singapore, Malaysia, Germany, and France made up the majority of visitors to the area, according to the County Bureau of Culture and Tourism.

As rescue and relief operations continue, the Chinese authorities have decided to close the scenic areas for tourists to ensure safety and manage the aftermath of the earthquake.

# France Reports First Case of New Mpox Virus Amid **Ongoing Global Epidemic**

France has confirmed its first case of the new mpox virus, the health ministry reported on Monday. This comes weeks after the World Health Organization (WHO) maintained its highest alert level for the epidemic. The confirmed case involves the clade 1b variant and was detected in the western Brittany region of France. The French health authorities have already implemented the necessary oversight measures in response to the case.

Mpox, previously known as monkeypox, is a viral disease related to smallpox, transmitted to humans through infected animals. It can also spread from person to person through close virus include fever, muscular aches, and large boil-like skin lesions, with the potential to be deadly in severe

The WHO declared a public health emergency for mpox in August and renewed the declaration on November 22 following an outbreak in the Democratic Republic of Congo. The disease has spread across 80 countries globally, with 19 of those cases in Africa.

France's health ministry clarified that the individual infected with the virus had not traveled to Central Africa, where several clade variants of mpox

### Oil Prices Dip as Demand **Optimism Wanes, but Tight Supply Supports**



Oil prices experienced a slight decline on Tuesday as optimism about global demand faded, despite concerns about tighter supply from Russia and Iran due to expanding Western sanctions. Brent crude futures fell by 25 cents, or 0.33%, to \$76.05 per barrel, while U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude dropped 44 cents, or 0.60%, to \$73.12 per barrel.

After experiencing gains for five consecutive days last week, both benchmarks slipped on Monday, retreating from their highest levels since October. The surge in oil prices had been fueled by expectations of fiscal stimulus in China, aimed at boosting the country's struggling economy. However, this week's price weakness appears to be a technical correction, according to Priyanka Sachdeva, senior market analyst at Phillip Nova. She cited softer global economic data, particularly from the U.S. and Germany, which dampened earlier optimism.

Analysts have pointed to recent developments in the Eurozone, where higher inflation in Germany has raised concerns that the European

Central Bank (ECB) may not be able to cut interest rates as quickly as anticipated. In the U.S., a decline in manufactured goods orders in November has also raised worries about economic slowdown. Market participants are now awaiting key economic reports later this week, such as the U.S. December non-farm payrolls data, for insights into U.S. interest rate policies and the broader oil demand out-

Despite these bearish signals, colder-than-normal weather in both the U.S. and Europe has driven up heating oil demand, offering some support to prices. Meteorologists forecast that U.S. temperatures will remain lower than usual through Jan. 21, with the coldest weather expected later this week.

Additionally, concerns over tightening supply from Russia and Iran, driven by sanctions, have helped stabilize oil prices. This has led to increased demand for Middle Eastern oil, as reflected in Saudi Arabia's decision to raise February oil prices to Asia, marking the first such increase in three months.

### Adani Group Stocks Surge, Boosted by **Positive Developments** and Investor Confidence



Chares of Adani Group companies experienced a Strong bullish trend on Tuesday, with significant gains observed across most of its stocks. Leading the charge were Adani Green Energy and Adani Power, which saw gains of 2.47% and 2.33%, respectively. Other stocks within the group also saw positive movement, with Adani Energy Solutions up by 1.96% and Adani Enterprises, the flagship company, climbing 1.72%.

The upward momentum extended to Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone (APSEZ), which was up 1.36%, and Adani Total Gas, which saw a more modest increase of 0.3%. In the cement sector, Ambuja Cements and ACC also rose by approximately 1.50%.

As of 1:19 p.m., the overall market capitalization of the Adani Group surged by around Rs 16,000 crore, bringing its total market value to nearly Rs 12.80 lakh crore. This strong performance is reflective of investor confidence, fueled by recent positive developments within the conglomerate.

One of the key highlights that has contributed to this optimism is the announcement of a joint venture between Adani Petrochemicals, a subsidiary of Adani Enterprises, and Indorama Resources. The joint venture, named 'Valor Petrochem,' will see Adani Petrochemicals hold a 50% stake. This collaboration is expected to leverage Indorama's expertise in the petrochemicals industry, enhancing Adani's position in this growing sector.

### India's Natural Gas Infrastructure Expands with Record-Breaking Pipeline Growth

f India's natural gas pipeline network has seen impressive growth, with the total length of operational pipelines increasing by 62.6% from 15,340 kilometers (km) in 2014 to 24,945 km as of September 2024. According to the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, approximately 10,805 km of additional pipelines are currently under construction, signaling a major expansion in the country's energy infrastructure.

The completion of these pipelines, authorized by the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB), will complete the national gas grid, connecting all major demand and supply centers across India. This strategic development aims to ensure easy access to natural gas nationwide, promoting uniform economic and social progress.

In addition to pipeline expansion, the Ministry Grid, One Tariff." Starting June 1, 2024, a level-



announced a key reform aimed at simplifying the natural gas tariff system. On January 7, 2024, the PNGRB amended the regulations to introduce a unified tariff for natural gas pipelines, following the vision of "One Nation, One

ized unified tariff of Rs 80.97/MMBTU will be applied, with three tariff zones based on distance from the gas source: up to 300 km, 300-1200 km, and beyond 1200 km. This reform will particularly benefit consumers in remote areas, where additional tariffs currently apply, and it will support the development of gas markets across the country.

The national gas grid includes interconnected pipeline networks operated by various entities, such as Indian Oil Corporation, GAIL (India), and Reliance Gas Pipelines, among others. PNGRB has also authorized the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) infrastructure across 307 geographical areas, which will cover nearly the entire country and its population. By September 2024, the total number of PNG (domestic) connections and CNG stations stood at 1.36 crore and 7,259, respectively.

### India's GDP Projected to Grow at 6.4% in FY 2024-25, **Marking a Four-Year Low**

Tndia's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) **⊥** is projected to grow at 6.4% in the fiscal year 2024-25, according to the first advance estimates released by the government on Tuesday. This forecast represents a significant slowdown, as it marks a four-year low and is a sharp decline from the 8.2% growth achieved in FY 2023-24.

The new projection of 6.4% is lower than the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) recent estimate of 6.6% for the same period, highlighting the challenges the econ-

omy is expected to face in the coming year. for the fiscal year 2024-25. The first advance estimates, provided by the National Statistical Office (NSO), offer an early indication of the country's economic outlook



The estimate reveals a notable slowdown in India's economic momentum as it transitions from a high growth phase in FY 2023-24, when the economy expanded by a robust 8.2%. The government's updated figures suggest that the growth rate of 6.4% in FY 2024-25 will be driven by various factors, including a potential slowdown in key sectors such as manufacturing and agriculture, which are vital to the nation's economy.

While the projected growth rate for FY 2024-25 is lower than expected, it still represents a solid performance, considering the global economic uncertainties

and domestic challenges. Factors such as inflationary pressures, tightening global monetary policies, and geopolitical tensions could also influence the pace of recovery.



According to a recent report from 404Media, a Reddit user shared their experience of coming across an AI-generated version of themselves in a post that showcased a slideshow of AI-created images. One of these images depicted the user standing in front of "an endless maze of mirrors," adding a surreal and introspective twist to the visuals.

The post, which is only visible to the user, came with the caption, "Imagine yourself reflecting on life in an endless maze of mirrors where you're the main focus." The concept

behind the image is designed to evoke deep personal reflection, with the AI-generated rendering adding an element of artistry and creativity. While some commenters initially doubted the authenticity of the post, the user confirmed the image was not real, prompting an inquiry by 404Media to Meta. In response, Meta confirmed that this was indeed part of a new experiment, which they had teased back in September.

This new feature explores the use of AI to create digital representations of users in imaginative and abstract settings. The images are generated based on the user's profile, capturing various aspects of their appearance in a way that is both creative and thought-provoking. The AI-generat-



ed content appears as part of Instagram's broader efforts to introduce more advanced technological tools into the platform, enhancing user engagement with personalized and immersive experiences.

# **ECB Rejects Boycott Call** for England-Afghanistan Champions Trophy Match The England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB)

has reportedly rejected calls to boycott England's upcoming Champions Trophy match against Afghanistan due to the treatment of women under the Taliban regime. The match, scheduled for February 26, 2025, has become a subject of controversy, with over 160 politicians urging the ECB to take a firm stand against the treatment of Afghan women by boycotting the game.

In a letter addressed to

ECB chief executive Richard Gould, Labour MP Tonia Antoniazzi, along with other political figures, called on the England men's team and officials to speak out against the "horrific treatment of women and girls" under the Taliban's rule. The letter also urged the ECB to send a message of solidarity with Afghan women by boycotting the match, condemning the regime's actions, and raising global awareness about the situation.

In response, Gould stated that while the ECB strongly condemns the treatment of women in Afghanistan, it favors a coordinated, international approach through the International Cricket Council (ICC) rather than unilateral actions. He emphasized that the ICC's commitment to the growth and development of women's cricket should be supported by all member nations, and that any boycott by individual countries might inadvertently support the Taliban's efforts to isolate Afghan society further.

The ECB confirmed its position of not scheduling bilateral cricket matches against Afghanistan, in line with its commitment to women's rights. However, Gould expressed that the ECB will continue to advocate for collective action within the ICC to address the situation more effectively.

While countries like Australia have withdrawn from playing against Afghanistan in recent years due to the Taliban's restrictions on women, both teams played in the 2023 ODI World Cup and the 2024 T20 World Cup. The ECB's stance highlights the ongoing debate over how to balance diplomatic and humanitarian concerns with the integrity of international sport.




