

Is AP not safe for NRI investments due to political intervention, irrespective of the parties? The issues coming to the forefront and the problems faced by NRIs who have invested in different sectors are raising this question. We have seen earlier about the NRI Hospital, where a power broker made those NRIs, who had founded it, silent spectators while the hospital changed hands.

Let's look at an instance where an NRI not only lost his money but also his confidence in the politicians, whom he had trusted to solve his problem. According to the details provided by the NRI, the story goes as follows:

In Eluru, Helapuri Institute of Technology and Science has been operating for the last 15 years. The chairman of the college is Mr. Ramesh, and the secretary is Mr. Atluri Srinivasa Rao. Three years ago, they were considering selling the institution and approached an NRI for the sale. The NRI discussed and agreed to invest Rs. 18 crores as per the agreement. They paid Rs. 8 crores, and for the balance, they agreed on a timeline as per the mutual understanding. However, elections were held, and the government changed. The management of the college had strong connections

They not only changed their tone but also their demands. They started asking for interest on the period during which the NRI had taken time to pay the balance amount. Additionally, they increased the sale price and raised the share price. After these typical discussions, the NRI team asked the management to show the accounts for the period, but received no satisfactory response. Meanwhile, allegations against the secretary, Mr. Atluri Srinivasa Rao, became a major issue, and the NRI sought clarification on this but to no avail.

Seeing the change in the college management's approach and attitude, the NRI team approached the local MLA, Chintamaneni Prabhakar, with a reference from an MP of the ruling party. Mr. Chintamaneni listened to the entire story and instructed the Sub Inspector of Pedavegi to take the complaint and not register it, as he himself would handle the issue. Following the MLA's directions, they went to the police station and met Sub Inspector Mr. Rajendra Kumar, who took a detailed complaint.

However, the situation took a turn from here. The NRI received a call from Millu Babu Maganti, who is associated with MLA Chintamaneni.

Yet, Mr. Millu continued calling and began threatening them directly. The NRI informed MLA Chintamaneni about these threats, but the MLA directed them to meet Mr. Millu only. The NRI concluded that the MLA had colluded with the management of the college and began pressuring them. Subsequently, the management issued termination letters to the NRI team from the directorship of the institution in an illegal manner.

This is the reality of NRI investments in the state. If the government cannot protect them and their investments, how can they expect NRIs to invest in the state? The so-called protector turned villain in this episode. If management with connections to the ruling party is allowed to act with impunity, what's the difference between the YSRC and TDP alliances ruling the state? The NRI team is now confused about whom to approach for justice. They are hoping the government will step in and resolve the issue, and that is their last hope. If the situation continues as it is, NRIs will rethink investing in the state, where political intervention seems inevitable at every stage.



### **Babu Vs Kejriwal Arrest:** A Case Study!

A common belief in Indian politics suggests that a chief ministerial candidate who is jailed often returns stronger in the next election. This has been proven in the past with leaders like Jagan Mohan Reddy and Revanth Reddy. However, recent political developments involving Chandrababu Naidu and Arvind Kejriwal provide a striking contrast, making for a fascinating case study.

Chandrababu Naidu was arrested six months before the Andhra Pradesh elections in the alleged Skill Development Scam, a move widely seen as a political vendetta by the YSRCP government. The arrest was intended to weaken the morale of the Telugu Desam Party (TDP) and its support base. However, the strategy backfired spectacularly. The public of Andhra Pradesh overwhelmingly rejected Jagan Mohan Reddy's tactics, propelling the NDA alliance, led by Chandrababu, to a stunning 93% strike rate victory in the 2024 elections. The very move meant to weaken him turned into a rallying point for voters, ensuring his return as Chief Minister and leaving Jagan without even the status of the Leader of the Opposition.

In contrast, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal was also arrested six months before elections in connection with the Delhi Liquor Scam. Like Chandrababu, Kejriwal's party, AAP, attempted to frame his arrest as a political conspiracy, hoping for a sympathy wave to carry them to victory. However, the results painted a completely different picture. Not only did AAP fail to secure a decisive mandate, but Kejriwal himself suffered a humiliating loss in the New Delhi assembly constituency.

The comparison between these two cases highlights the crucial role of public perception. While Chandrababu Naidu's arrest was widely seen as politically motivated and unjust, Kejriwal's case was linked to corruption, which significantly damaged his credibility. Voters in Andhra Pradesh turned their frustration into a historic electoral mandate in Naidu's favor, whereas in Delhi, the corruption allegations against AAP eroded public trust, leading to Kejriwal's personal defeat. Ultimately, these events prove that not every arrest translates into political resurgence. The people's perception of whether a leader is a victim of political targeting or genuinely involved in wrongdoing can make all the difference.

The International Energy Festival of Kerala (IEFK-2025), held from February 7-9, emphasized the urgent need for enhanced energy efficiency measures across India. The Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), under the Ministry of Power, has urged State Designated Agencies (SDAs) to actively contribute to the national energy conservation movement, which plays a crucial role in economic growth and climate change mitigation. BEE has outlined a target of 150 million tonnes of oil equivalent (Mtoe) in energy savings by 2030, with Andhra Pradesh receiving a specific goal of 6.68 Mtoe. Experts at the event highlighted the importance of public-private collaboration in achieving these ambitious goals.

#### **Urgency of Climate Action**

The energy sector contributes nearly 75% of global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. Without significant intervention, global temperatures could surpass the critical 1.5°C limit set by the Paris Agreement. The World Health Organization (WHO) has identified air pollution as a major health risk, linked to respiratory and cardiovascular diseases, while poor waste management exacerbates water contamination.


#### To strengthen India's commitment to climate action, BEE has introduced two key guidelines:

- Detailed Procedure for Compliance Mechanism
- Accreditation Procedure and Eligibility Criteria for Carbon Verification Agencies

These initiatives aim to bolster India's Carbon Market Framework (ICM), aligning with the nation's target to reduce emission intensity by 45% by 2030 and achieve net-zero emissions by 2070.

#### **India's Carbon Market: Key Features**

• Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS): Allows industries to trade carbon credits, encouraging



emission reductions.

- **Compliance Mechanism: Industries exceeding** reduction targets earn credits, while those falling short must purchase them.
- Offset Mechanism: Renewable energy and low-carbon projects can voluntarily participate, expanding credit availability.
- Regulatory Oversight: The ICM portal, developed with the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC), ensures transparency in carbon trading.

Andhra Pradesh's Commitment to Energy Efficiency The Government of Andhra Pradesh, under Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu, recently launched three major energy efficiency programs in collaboration with Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL):

- URJAVEER Program: Promoting energy-efficient appliances.
- National Efficiency Cooking Program: Supplying induction stoves to Anganwadi Centers.
- Energy-Efficient Appliances for PMAY Households: Encouraging voluntary adoption of efficient appliances in government housing schemes.

These initiatives are expected to significantly accelerate energy savings and reduce greenhouse gas emissions, reinforcing Andhra Pradesh's leadership in energy conservation. The IEFK-2025 commended Kerala's efforts in positioning itself as a carbon-free state and emphasized the need for sustained climate action nationwide.

## Praja Rajyam **Transformed** Into Jana Sena, **Says Megastar**

Megastar Chiranjeevi, who attended the pre-release event of Vishwak Sen's upcoming film Laila as the chief guest, made key remarks about Praja Rajyam and Jana Sena. While introducing Karate Raju, a former associate from Praja Rajyam, Chiranjeevi unexpectedly raised the slogan "Jai Jana Sena," drawing loud applause from the audience.

Chiranjeevi went on to state that Praja Rajyam has now transformed into Jana Sena, expressing his happiness over the evolution of the party. His statement quickly gained traction on social media, with both Mega fans and Jana Sena supporters celebrating his remarks.

Chiranjeevi had founded the Praja Rajyam Party on August 26, 2008, with the vision that "in Praja Rajyam, people are the rulers, and I am their heir." Pawan Kalyan led its youth wing, Yuvarajyam. In the 2009 Andhra Pradesh Assembly elections, the party won 18 out of 294 seats with an 18% vote share. However, Chiranjeevi later merged Praja Rajyam with the Congress in August 2011 and went on to serve as a Union Minister.

During the state's bifurcation, Pawan Kalyan launched the Jana Sena Party, opting to support the TDP-BJP alliance in 2014 instead of contesting. In 2019, Jana Sena won one assembly seat. However, in the recent Andhra Pradesh elections, the party secured a massive victory, winning all 21 assembly seats it contested, along with two MP seats. As part of the ruling coalition with TDP and BJP, Pawan Kalyan has now taken charge as the Deputy Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh.

### **All-Party Round Table on Irrigation** & Backward Region **Development**

#### Govt Allocated ₹320 Cr for Emergency Irrigation Works

Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu conducted an inspection of the Godavari watershed works in Yalamanchili, Palakollu constituency of West Godavari district. Speaking on the occasion, he criticized the previous YSRCP government for its negligence, stating that under Jagan Mohan Reddy's five-year rule, the irrigation department was completely ignored, leading to weakened and dangerous infrastructure. To address these issues, the Chandrababu Naidu-led government sanctioned ₹320 crore for emergency irrigation works across the state. The minister set a deadline for completion by March, emphasizing the urgency of the repairs.

Recalling the flood crisis in Godavari, he said that due to lack of maintenance funds under Jagan's government, locals and youth had to work through the night to prevent dam breaches. The new administration is now prioritizing strengthening of dams, filling of drains, and repairing crucial structures such as gates, shutters, locks, and ropes-all of which were previously neglected.

A round table meeting on irrigation projects and regional development was held under the aegis of the Backward Regions Development Forum in Vijayawada. The meeting saw the participation of several political leaders, farmers' associations, social activists, and student representatives, with notable figures such as former Union Minister Chintamohan, ex-MP Vadde Shobhanadeswara Rao, CPI State Secretary Ramakrishna, and CPM leaders in attendance. In a hard-hitting speech, former Union Minister Chintamohan squarely blamed past Chief Ministers from Rayalaseema for the region's stagnation. Listing out past CMs, he pointed out that despite their prolonged tenure, the region continues to suffer from underdevelopment and lack of irrigation projects. "Our Chief Ministers have forgotten us. Chandrababu Naidu ruled for 15 years, YSR and Jagan for 11 years combined, and others for nearly two decades. Yet, Rayalaseema remains backward," he said. Chintamohan also revisited the long-standing debate on Andhra Pradesh's capital, questioning the constant shifts from Kurnool to Hyderabad, then to Amaravati, later to Visakhapatnam, and now back to Amaravati.

### **Minister Narayana Announces Completion of 2.3 Lakh Houses Soon**

## JanaSena Suspends Kiran Royal Amid Serious Allegations

JanaSena has taken strict disciplinary action against Tirupati in-charge Kiran Royal, suspending him from all party activities until further notice. This move comes after serious allegations of sexual and financial exploitation surfaced against him, leading to widespread controversy.

The issue gained traction after YSR Congress leaders and social media activists circulated videos and audio clips in which a woman named Lakshmi from Bairagapattu, Tirupati, accused Kiran Royal of fraud, threats, and abuse. According to reports, Lakshmi had loaned Kiran Royal nearly ₹20 lakh, and over



time, the amount increased to over ₹1 crore due to additional financial dealings. She alleged that when she asked for repayment, Kiran threatened her



and her children, forcing her to sign bonds and checks worth ₹30 lakh under duress. Unable to bear the harassment, Lakshmi attempted suicide and record-

ed a heartbreaking video, detailing the threats she faced. In the video, she stated that she wanted her money to go to her children even after her death. She is currently undergoing treatment at CMC Vellore, and her condition is being closely monitored.

Following the widespread circulation of these allegations, JanaSena leadership acted swiftly, suspending Kiran Royal from all party-related activities. In an official statement, the party announced that an internal investigation committee has been formed to examine the matter, and Kiran Royal will remain suspended until the inquiry is completed.

Reacting to the allegations, Kiran Royal has strongly denied any wrongdoing, claiming that this is a politically motivated attack aimed at tarnishing his reputation. He has met with JanaSena's legal team and assured them that he will fight the accusations legally. The controversy has further escalated as YSR Congress leaders actively push the narrative, highlighting Kiran Royal's past political jabs at Jagan Mohan Reddy. Many believe that his recent criticism of Jagan's governance and the "2.0" campaign may have triggered this political retaliation.

With the allegations and videos going viral on social media, this case has turned into a major political storm in Tirupati. The investigation's outcome will determine the future course of action for both Kiran Royal and JanaSena.



## **MP Purandeswari Asserts BJP's Commitment to Development**

In the past few days, social media has been buzzing with reports that former Rajamahendravaram MP Undavalli Arun Kumar is set to join the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP). However, political observers and ruling party leaders see this as a non-issue, arguing that Undavalli has always functioned as an unofficial YSRCP spokesperson despite projecting himself as a neutral intellectual.

During 2014-19, Undavalli frequently targeted TDP chief N. Chandrababu Naidu. Over the last five years, he remained silent on the excesses of the Jagan Mohan Reddy government, while also taking indirect jabs at Eenadu Group Chairman Ramoji Rao, who was vocal against YSRCP policies. Now, with the political tide turning and YSRCP in opposition, his formal entry into the party seems inconsequential.

Critics argue that Undavalli's so-called neutrality has always leaned toward YSRCP. His lack of response to Jagan filing cases against his own mother and sister raises questions

about his commitment to justice and integrity. Though he calls himself a true follower of YS Rajasekhara Reddy (YSR), his silence on the treatment of YSR's wife and daughter by Jagan's leadership has not gone unnoticed.

At over 70 years old, Undavalli holds little electoral value, as he is neither in a position to contest elections nor capable of mobilizing significant voter support. At best, he might hold a few press conferences, but his rhetoric would remain the same, regardless of his party affiliation.

Sources within the TDP and its allies suggest they are unconcerned about this development. Given Undavalli's history of opposing the ruling coalition, his potential alignment with YSRCP will only strengthen their counter-narrative. If he starts criticizing the government after officially joining YSRCP, it will only reinforce allegations of bias and weaken his credibility further. For now, TDP circles appear least bothered, viewing this news as irrelevant to the state's current political landscape.

## **VMC Malaria Department Caught in Corruption Allegations**

- Biologist Surya Kumar Nayak accused of mismanagement and illegal earnings.
- Allegations of Bribery and Fraud

1. PDP (Primary Disease Prevention): Workers are supposed

to inspect water tanks and storage areas house-to-house. However, instead of covering all houses, they only visit a few, take photos, and submit them as false reports.

2. ALO (Anti-Larval Operations): Chemicals meant for spraying in drains and vacant lands are allegedly sold in the black market instead of being used for mosquito control. 3. Fogging Operations: The department receives 700-800 liters of diesel oil daily for fogging, but only 100 liters are reportedly used. The remaining diesel is allegedly siphoned off and sold outside. 4. Pyratnom Spraying: This includes hand pumping and drone spraying. However, delays and irregularities in distribution mean the chemicals and oil do not reach the divisions on time. The division's chemical and oil stock is stored at Krishna Lanka Rani Gari's garden but is not distributed properly to the field workers. Inspectors are also denied access to these essential resources. Reports suggest that none of the Malaria Department workers are attending their duties properly. Instead of conducting fieldwork, they submit manipulated photos to higher authorities. Moreover, the Section Inspectors (SIs) in the divisions are allegedly supplying liquor to the Biologist twice a week as



part of an unofficial arrangement. It is alleged that each SI is required to pay the Biologist Rs. 5,000 per month, particularly after surprise inspections. During the Budameru floods, it was claimed that only 50 workers were deployed, but reports were manipulated to show 150 workers, raising questions about fraudulent wage claims.Accord-

### **MP Kesineni Shivnath Launches** 'Vikasit Panchayat' Initiative for **Rural Development**

**TPN Correspondent** Vijayawada, Feb 10 In a significant move toward rural development and self-employment, Vijayawada MP Kesineni Shivnath (Chinni) has launched the 'Vikasit Panchayat' initiative to transform 294 villages in his

parliamentary constituency into model panchayats.

Under this program, 100 youth have been selected for self-employment training in collaboration with the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (NIRDPR). In the first phase, 33 youth from different mandals have been sent to Hyderabad NIRDPR for a week-long training program from February 10 to 16. The selected youth belong to: A.Kondur Mandal (Tiruvur Constituency) – 9 youth

The Malaria Department of Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) is facing serious allegations of corruption, with officials accused of widespread malpractice and financial irregularities. The department, which oversees health, sanitation, and Ayurveda services, is under scrutiny for mismanagement and misuse of resources.

The department is led by Biologist Surya Kumar Navak, who is also serving as the District Rural Assistant Malaria Officer. There are six Malaria Inspectors under his command, but reports indicate that the department's key functions are not being carried out properly.

The Malaria Department follows four primary work procedures, but none are reportedly executed correctly:

ing to sources, Biologist Surya Kumar Nayak is making an illegal income of Rs. 3–4 lakh per month from various corrupt practices.

A citizen named Ranga Nayak has lodged a formal complaint against Surya Kumar Nayak in the Lokayukta, detailing the corruption within the Malaria Department. A similar complaint was also submitted to the Commissioner, urging action against those involved. Despite these complaints, there has been no response from the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB), leading to speculation among Vijayawada residents about potential collusion between officials. Many are questioning why no investigation has been initiated despite clear evidence of corruption. The public is now demanding a thorough audit of the Malaria Department's operations and strict action against those responsible for the alleged misappropriation of public funds.

Vijayawada, Feb 10 : A controversy erupted at the Sri Kanaka Durga Temple in Vijayawada after a devotee allegedly found hair in the prasadam. The incident, which was captured in photos and posted on social media, quickly gained traction, leading to widespread criticism.

Before the issue escalated further, Endowments Minister Anam Jayakumar promptly responded, apologizing to the devotee and assuring that corrective mea-



sures would be taken. He emphasized that food hygiene protocols would be strengthened to prevent similar occurrences in the future.

Temple authorities have reportedly initiated an internal inquiry and are expected to enhance quality control in prasadam preparation. Officials urged devotees to report any concerns directly to temple management rather than relying solely on social media. The viral photos have triggered discussions about food safety at religious institutions, with devotees demanding stricter monitoring in the preparation of sacred offerings.

The association also decided to form ad hoc committees to conduct district elections and complete the state-level elections by the end



### **Dhavaleswaram Barrage Needs Minister Nimmala's Attention**



- A Historic Irrigation Marvel in Decline

Once the epicenter of irrigation management in Andhra Pradesh, Dhavaleswaram Cotton Barrage is now reduced to merely a statue of Sir Arthur Cotton, with most administrative offices being relocated to different areas. The Sir Arthur Cotton Barrage, recognized as a World Heritage Site by the International Commission on Irrigation and Drainage (ICID) in Australia, continues to serve as the lifeline for the Godavari districts. However, despite its international significance, the barrage and its operations have been neglected due to political interference and lack of attention from previous governments.

Previously, the Eastern Delta, Central Delta, and Western Delta offices were established at Dhavaleswaram to ensure However, with their relocation constant monitoring of irriga- to distant areas, senior offition water supply, safety, and maintenance of the barrage. However, these offices have now been moved to Ramachandrapuram, Amalapuram, and Nidadavolu, causing major disruptions in water management. With only the Circle Office and the Cotton Statue remaining, the headworks department is now under scrutiny for alleged corruption, raising concerns about mismanagement and inefficiency in water regulation.

Between 1970 and 1982, the barrage was reconstructed, raising its height to 10.6 meters and increasing its gross water storage capacity to 2.93 TMC feet. The 175 gates, spanning 3,599 meters, ensured a steady supply of 100 TMC feet of water annually to 65 mandals across the Godavari region, irrigating over 10 lakh acres of farmland.

To efficiently manage the water flow, flood control, and irrigation supply, the Eastern Delta, Central Delta, and Western Delta offices were originally positioned near the Dhavaleswaram Circle Office. These offices played a crucial role in supervising irrigation projects, monitoring flood conditions, and ensuring timely release of water to agricultural lands. cials now travel over 60 km

### **Tragic Accident in Palnadu: Four** Women Died, Several Injured

A tragic accident occurred at Bollavaram in Muppalla mandal when a tractor carrying chilli labourers lost control and overturned into the Madala canal. The accident resulted in the deaths of four women, while several others sustained severe injuries.

The deceased have been identified as Madhira Gangamma (40), Madhira Samrajyam (43), Tenepalli Padma (45), and Chakkera Madhavi (30), all from Chagantivaripalem village. At the time of the accident, the tractor was carrying around 30 female labourers who were traveling for chilli harvesting work.

Local police and residents immediately initiated rescue operations, shifting the injured



to Sattenapalli Government Hospital for treatment. The bodies of the deceased were sent to the Sattenapalli Government Area Hospital for post-mortem examination. Authorities are investigating the cause of the accident while medical staff continue to provide care to the injured labourers.

#### Scholarships Distributed to Talented Kapu Students in Razole





## **Factors Behind AAP's Defeat in the 2025 Delhi Assembly Elections**

The 2025 Delhi Assembly elections have as excuses, further alienating the elecdelivered a resounding defeat to the Aam torate. Aadmi Party (AAP), with party leader Arvind Kejriwal conceding defeat to BJP candidate Parvesh Sharma in the New Delhi constituency by a margin of 3,182 votes. AAP, which rose to prominence on the back of the 2011 Anna Hazare-led anti-corruption movement, has seen its political fortunes change significantly. Despite being seen as a champion of transparency and governance reforms in its early years, the party's internal issues, governance failures, and corruption allegations played a key role in the electoral outcome.

#### 1. Anti-Incumbency and **Governance Failures**

the inevitable challenge of anti-incumbency. Despite some welfare-oriented policies, the party struggled to address the key concerns of the people, particularly the middle class, which had been a loyal voter base. The promises made in the 15-point "Kejriwal Ki Guarantee," including freebies and waivers, were not enough to convince voters. The lack of concrete plans to address critical issues like air and water pollution, sanitation, waste management, and inflation eroded public confidence. Additionally, the party's constant finger-pointing at the Centre and refusal to take responsibility for governance failures were perceived

#### 2. Corruption Allegations and Damage to Kejriwal's Image

Kejriwal's carefully crafted image as a corruption-free, "common man" leader suffered a severe blow with the emergence of corruption allegations, including his involvement in the Delhi liquor policy scam and the "Sheesh Mahal" controversy. These scandals raised questions about his integrity and tarnished the party's image as an alternative to traditional politics. The public's disillusionment with Kejriwal's leadership was palpable, especially when it came to allegations of extravagance in the renovation of the Chief Minister's residence. AAP's decade-long rule in Delhi faced This marked the collapse of the narrative that had made AAP a popular choice Ultimately, the defeat of AAP in Delhi

The party effectively consolidated its voter base across various demographic and caste lines, while also winning over disillusioned AAP supporters. The BJP's extensive digital campaign, spearheaded by platforms like the NaMo app, and its ground-level outreach through key leaders, contributed significantly to the party's victory.

### **Delhi Elections: How BJP's** Strategy of No CM Face **Worked in Its Favor**



In the Delhi Assembly elections, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) achieved a remarkable victory, marking the third consecutive win for the party in 2023, following triumphs in Haryana and Maharashtra. These states were initially seen as tough battlegrounds for the BJP, but Prime Minister Narendra Modi's influence has only grown since the general elections. His leadership continues to shape the party's dominance, even in states once considered challenging.

The BJP's victory in Delhi is especially significant, not only because it marks a return to power after 27 years but also due to the scale of the mandate. From a mere eight seats in the previous Delhi assembly, the BJP surged to 48 out of 70 seats, turning a tough contest into a sweeping victory. In contrast, Arvind Kejriwal's Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), which had secured 62 seats in the previous election, plummeted to just 22. This outcome reflects the power of the BJP's campaign strategy, which resonated deeply with voters.

One of the most striking aspects of the BJP's victory was its ability to defeat Kejriwal in his own constituency, New Delhi. The BJP's Parvesh Verma triumphed over Kejriwal by over 4,000 votes. Kejriwal, who rose to prominence in 2013 by defeating Sheila Dikshit, had positioned himself as an alternative to PM Modi and campaigned across multiple states. However, this overextension, coupled with scandals like the alleged liquor scam, ultimately weakened his position. Kejriwal's defeat in New Delhi demonstrated that his political stature had taken a significant hit.

Additionally, Kejriwal's closest allies, including his former deputy Manish Sisodia, suffered defeats in constituencies once considered "safe" for AAP. The entire leadership of AAP, with the exception of Atishi, faced a crushing loss. Modi's ability to deliver on promises, including better governance and infrastructure, helped dismantle the belief that Kejriwal's promises of free services would guarantee loyalty from low-income voters.

One of the key factors in BJP's success was its strategy of not presenting a Chief Ministerial face for Delhi. While the absence of a strong local leader initially seemed like a disadvantage, the BJP effectively used Modi's national appeal to counter Kejriwal.

#### 3. Internal Discord and the **Congress Factor**

The failure of AAP and the Congress to form an electoral alliance in Delhi played a role in the party's loss. The internal tensions within the opposition bloc, including the Congress's strategic decision to undermine AAP following its setbacks in Punjab and Goa, left the party isolated. This internal discord was exacerbated by Congress's focus on weak-

gardless of its welfare initiatives, can afford to ignore the pressing concerns of its citizens. Short-term political gains, such as freebies, cannot substitute for effective governance. As demonstrated by AAP's loss, failure to address real issues and connect with the electorate can lead to severe long-term consequences, as reflected in the Congress party's failure to secure even a single seat for the third consecutive election. ### **RBI Begins Rate-Cutting Cycle Amid Economic Uncertainty**

In its February 2025 policy review, the Reserve Bank of India's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) embarked on a rate-cutting cycle, driven by the evolving growth and inflation trends. The committee's decision to reduce rates comes at a time when global uncertainties loom large, reflected most notably in the depreciation of the Indian rupee against the US dollar. Despite the challenging global economic environment, the MPC saw a window of opportunity to initiate a rate cut, as domestic inflationary pressures have eased and economic growth shows signs of stabilization.

Looking back to the MPC's December 2024 meeting, the economic landscape was markedly different. At that time, India's Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation had breached the 6% mark, surpassing the upper limit of the Reserve Bank's medium-term inflation target range of 2-6%. This high inflation rate made it clear that a rate cut was off the table in December, despite the country's GDP growth decelerating to a disappointing 5.4% in the second quarter of fiscal year 2024-25. With inflationary concerns still fresh, the outlook for the economy appeared precarious.

However, by February 2025, the economic situation had shifted. CPI inflation had receded significantly, and the outlook for inflation in 2025-26 appeared more moderate. High-frequency economic indicators also pointed to a potential recovery in domestic growth, especially following the economic downturn in the second quarter. This shift in inflation and growth expectations provided the MPC with the justification to start a rate-cutting cycle, signaling a move towards more accommodative monetary policy.

Despite this, analysts predict that the rate cut cycle will likely be gradual and shallow. With ongoing global uncertainties, including geopolitical tensions and external economic pressures, the RBI faces a balancing act in fostering growth while maintaining price stability. The depreciation of the rupee against the dollar further complicates the situation, potentially raising import costs and keeping inflationary pressures alive.

## **Is Air Pollution Making India Age Faster?**

The blanket of smog that envelops numerous cities worldwide, including India's capital, Delhi, is not just a health hazard that chokes our lungs but also a significant contributor to premature aging. Studies have shown that air pollution can accelerate biological aging, shortening our lifespans. India, with its vast population, faces this grim reality daily, as several major cities, including Delhi, Kolkata, and Mumbai, consistently rank among



the most polluted cities

globally, according to real-time data from IQAir.

Air pollution has long been a critical issue, particularly in urban areas, where concentrations of particulate matter (PM) and toxic gases such as sulphur dioxide, nitrogen dioxide, and carbon monoxide are dangerously high. Fossil fuel emissions, primarily from the energy and transportation sectors, are the primary culprits behind this problem. The health risks posed by air pollution are profound. A 2021 study estimated

that 10.2 million premature deaths occur globally each year due to particulate matter from fossil fuel emissions, with nearly 5 million attributed to outdoor air pollution alone. These numbers are expected to rise, with a projected 4.3 million urban deaths by 2050.

India, the world's most populous nation, bears a significant portion of this burden. The country ranks third globally in air pollution levels, and with 65% of its population under the age of 35, the long-term impacts on the younger population are particularly concerning.

A key biological factor in aging is telomere length. Telomeres are protective caps at the end of chromosomes, which shorten each time a cell divides. Over time, this shortening contributes to the aging process. Recent studies have shown a direct connection between air pollution exposure and shorter telomere length, effectively speeding up the biological aging of cells. As toxic substances like reactive oxygen species (ROS) generated by pollutants damage our cells, inflammation and stress follow, accelerating telomere degradation.

**CM Stalin slams Centre** over US' treatment of Indian deportees, Mahakumbh deaths TPN Correspondent | Delhi

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M K Stalin has sharply criticized the BJP-led central government for its handling of two major issues— the mistreatment of Indians deported from the US and the stampede deaths during

the Mahakumbh festival in Uttar

Pradesh. Addressing a public meeting, Stalin condemned Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government for "betraying" Tamil Nadu. He accused the Centre of failing to release the state's rightful share of funds and neglecting the state during natural disasters. Stalin warned that if the central government did not amend its approach, it would lose the peo-

ple's respect every day.

On the Mahakumbh stampede, Stalin expressed his concern over the deaths of at least 48 people, blaming the Uttar Pradesh BJP government for inadequate safety measures. While the BJP government reported 30 deaths, Stalin and others contested this figure. "The media reports suggest the death toll is 48, and some leaders believe the actual number could be higher," he said. Stalin also referenced claims by Samajwadi Party leader Akhilesh Yadav, who alleged that bodies were removed with earth movers, further emphasizing the lack of accountability in the incident. Stalin questioned the government's duty to ensure the safety of the devotees and criticized the refusal to discuss the issue in Parliament.

Manipur CM's resignation 'belated', people now await visit by 'frequentflier PM': Congress TPN Correspondent | Delhi

The Congress party on Sunday termed the resignation of Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh as "belated," claiming that the people of the state were now awaiting a visit from Prime Minister Narendra Modi, whom they referred to as a "frequent-flier." The remarks came shortly after Singh submitted his resignation to Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla at the Raj Bhavan in Imphal.

Jairam Ramesh, the All India Congress Committee (AICC) general secretary in charge of communications, stated that the Congress was prepared to move a no-confidence motion against Singh and his council of ministers in the upcoming session of the Manipur Assembly on Monday. Ramesh emphasized that the Congress had been demanding Singh's resignation since the violent unrest in the state began in May 2023, calling the resignation long overdue.

In a post on X, Ramesh remarked, "Sensing the climate, the Manipur chief minister has just resigned. This was a demand that the Congress has been making since early May 2023, when Manipur erupted." He further criticized Prime Minister Modi's lack of engagement with the crisis in Manipur, stating, "The chief minister's resignation was belated. The people of Manipur now await a visit by our frequent-flier prime minister who is off to France and the US now — and who has found neither the time nor the inclination to go to Manipur these past 20 months."

### **Prayagraj Sangam Station Temporarily Closed Amid Rising Crowds for Maha Kumbh**

In response to the growing influx of pilgrims during the ongoing Maha Kumbh, the railway authorities have temporarily closed the Prayagraj Sangam station for the general public. However, train operations will continue as usual, with no disruptions in travel services. To manage the crowd efficiently, additional Railway Protection Force (RPF) personnel have been deployed across all stations in Prayagraj.



The CM also condemned the handcuffing and shackling of Indians deported by the US, calling it "cruel." He expressed deep emotional distress over the mistreatment of the 104 deportees, questioning External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar's response, which appeared to justify the US's actions.

To further streamline the flow of devotees, a one-way travel system has been implemented at the station, and it will remain in place until further notice. Under this system, pilgrims will only be allowed entry into Prayagraj Junction from the city side at Platform No. 1, while exiting will be directed through the Civil Lines side, specifically at Platforms No. 6 and 10. The decision to



implement these measures aims to nation stations. These shelters are ensure the safety and smooth movement of passengers during this busy period, as confirmed by Amit Singh, the Public Relations Officer (PRO) of the Railway Division. In addition, pilgrims will need color-coded tickets to access the designated shelters at the station, with each shelter assigned based on passengers' desti-

equipped with essential services such as temporary ticket counters, toilets, and resting areas. To accommodate reserved ticket holders, access will be provided through Gate No. 5. Passengers are encouraged to arrive well in advance of their train's departure to avoid delays and ensure a hassle-free journey.

### **Russia's Su-57, US' F-35 Fighter Jets To Take Part In Aero India**

Its inclusion in the airshow offers a unique opportunity for visitors to see firsthand the capabilities of one of the most advanced aircraft in the world.

Aero India 2025's theme, "The Runway to a Billion Opportunities," will provide a rare opportunity to compare Eastern and Western fifth-generation fighter technologies side by side, giving defense analysts, military personnel, and aviation enthusiasts valuable insights.

The participation of both the Su-57 and F-35 at Aero India underscores India's growing importance as a key hub for international defense and aerospace collaboration, solidifying its role in the global defense landscape.

### Silent rally in Kolkata on RG Kar victim's birthday, demanding justice

On Sunday, February 9, doctors and residents of Kolkata took part in a silent rally to mark the first birthday of the RG Kar hospital medic who tragically lost her life last year. The rally, which aimed to demand justice for the victim, began at College Square near the Calcutta University campus and made its way toward RG Kar Medical College and Hospital in north Kolkata. However, it was halted at the hospital gate by security personnel.

A strong presence of Kolkata Police and CISF jawans was deployed around the hospital, with officers speaking to the rally participants. The marchers had hoped to reach a specific point inside the hospital premises, where a plaque in memory of the victim had been set up by her colleagues. The hospital has been under the protection of the CISF following the rape and murder of the post-graduate trainee, an incident that sparked widespread outrage and protests across the country.

The day also marked six months since the tragic crime occurred on August 9, 2024. The victim's parents took part in another rally in North 24 Parganas district to commemorate their daughter's birthday. They expressed dissatisfaction with the CBI's investigation into the case and reiterated their demand for the arrest of anyone else involved in the crime



and the initiation of further legal proceedings.

In a recent court ruling, Sanjay Roy, the sole accused in the case, was convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment. Despite this, the victim's family and supporters continue to call for justice, believing that there may be others who were involved.

The participants of the rally covered their mouths with black cloth and held placards demanding justice. The march, organized by 'Abhaya Manch,' was kept silent to respect the upcoming Class 10 West Bengal school board examinations. The rally served as a reminder of the ongoing quest for justice and the enduring impact of the tragedy on the community.





## Lebanon Forms New Government Amid US Pressure and Reconstruction Hopes


- New Lebanese cabinet formed after weeks of negotiations, limiting Hezbollah's sway.
- US welcomes government, stressing the need for financial reforms and stability.
- Priority set on implementing UN resolution and securing international reconstruction aid.

Lebanon's newly appointed Prime Minister, Nawaf Salam, unveiled a 24-member cabinet on Saturday, marking a pivotal moment for the country amid the aftermath of a devastating war between Israel and Hezbollah. The formation of the government follows more than three weeks of political negotiations, with the country's political factions, which traditionally allocate government posts along sectarian lines, navigating the delicate balance of power.

The cabinet's primary goals are to implement financial reforms, initiate the reconstruction of war-torn areas, and execute a crucial United Nations resolution related to stability along Lebanon's border with Israel. These objectives are seen as critical for restoring Lebanon's international credibility and securing much-needed financial assistance.

The process, however, was influenced by intense external pressure, particularly from the United States, which has been vocal in its opposition to Hezbollah's influence within Lebanon's political sphere. US Deputy Middle East envoy, Morgan Ortagus, labeled Hezbollah's involvement in the cabinet as a "red line" and thanked Israel for its successful military strikes against the group, sparking protests within Lebanon. Despite this, Hezbollah's ally Amal, led by Parliament Speaker Nabih Berri, secured four ministerial positions in the new cabi-



net, ensuring Hezbollah and its allies do not have veto power in key decisions.

The new cabinet's formation is seen as an essential step toward implementing reforms that could unlock financial support from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) and Gulf countries, vital for Lebanon's economic recovery. Lebanon has been grappling with a severe financial collapse, a catastrophic explosion at the Beirut port, and the aftermath of a prolonged war with Israel, all of which have devastated the country.

The United Nations has welcomed the cabinet formation, emphasizing the importance of implementing UN Security Council Resolution 1701, which calls for disarming

armed groups in Lebanon, a clear reference to Hezbollah. Prime Minister Salam emphasized that the government would prioritize this resolution, along with ensuring the withdrawal of Israeli troops from southern Lebanon and the deployment of the Lebanese army in the region by February 18. The newly formed government now faces the task of drafting a policy statement outlining its approach and priorities, after which it will need to secure a vote of confidence in Lebanon's parliament. The appointment of Prime Minister Salam, following the election of President Joseph Aoun, signals a significant shift in Lebanon's political landscape, especially in light of Hezbollah's weakened position due to recent military losses.



## Earthquake Of Magnitude 7.6 Shakes Caribbean, Tsunami Advisory Issued

A powerful earthquake with a magnitude of 7.6 struck the Caribbean Sea on Saturday evening (local time), according to the US Geological Survey (USGS). The quake, which originated north of Honduras, occurred about 130 miles (209 kilometers) from the coast of the Cayman Islands. It was recorded at a shallow depth of 10 kilometers (6.21 miles), intensifying concerns over potential tsunamis in the region.

1 and 3 meters was forecast for parts of Cuba's coastline. Smaller waves between 0.3 to 1 meter were expected along the coasts of Honduras and the Cayman Islands.

### Not Chomping At The Bit: Elon Musk On His Plans To Acquire TikTok

Billionaire entrepreneur Elon Musk has stated that he has no interest in acquiring TikTok, the popular short-video platform currently embroiled in national security concerns in the United States. Musk's comments were shared online over the weekend after being made during a January conference hosted by The WELT Group, part of the German media company Axel Springer SE. The Tesla CEO joined the summit via video.

"I have not put in a bid for TikTok," Musk clarified, shortly after US President Donald Trump expressed openness to Musk purchasing the app, owned by the Chinese company ByteDance. Musk further explained that he does not use Tik-Tok personally and is not familiar with its format. "I'm not chomping at the bit to acquire TikTok; I do not acquire companies in general. It's quite rare," Musk added, pointing out that his acquisition of social media platform Twitter, now known as X, was an unusual move for him. "I usually build companies from scratch," he emphasized.

The US government has raised national security concerns over TikTok, claiming that China could compel ByteDance to share data from American users. Despite these claims, TikTok has consistently denied that it has or would ever share such data with the Chinese government. In response to these concerns, former President Trump signed an executive order that set a deadline for ByteDance to sell TikTok's US assets by January 19 or face a potential ban. Apple and Google have refrained from reinstating TikTok on their app stores due to a US law in effect since the controversy began.





### Pakistan Army should return to its constitutional limits: Imran Khan TPN Correspondent | Islamabad

Former Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan has penned an open letter to Army Chief Gen. Asim Munir, sharply criticizing the military's unlawful actions and its continued interference in politics. In his letter, Khan urged the military to "return to its constitutional limits," addressing his concerns over the growing involvement of the armed forces in national governance.

The letter, posted on X (formerly Twitter), follows Khan's previous correspondence from February 3, where he called for the military to reassess its approach toward national security and governance. In the new letter, Khan highlighted his mistreatment in prison, specifically detailing his 20-day confinement in a death-row cell, where he had no access to sunlight or electricity. He alleged that the treatment was part of a larger effort to break his resolve, describing it as inhumane and unlawful.

Khan's latest letter also expressed disappointment over the military's response to his earlier communication. He criticized the military's dismissive and irresponsible reaction, which he said reflected a lack of concern for the reputation of Pakistan's armed forces. He warned that the widening rift between the military and the public could have dangerous consequences for the country's future.

This ongoing criticism of the military comes amid a broader political crisis in Pakistan, with Khan's party, Tehreek-i-Insaf (PTI), facing increasing pressure from both the military and the government. Following the earthquake, the US Tsunami Warning System issued alerts for the Caribbean Sea, particularly affecting the coastal areas of Honduras. The warning highlighted the risk of hazardous tsunami waves within 620 miles of the epicenter, extending along the coasts of the Cayman Islands, Jamaica, Cuba, Mexico, Honduras, the Bahamas, Belize, Haiti, Costa Rica, Panama, Nicaragua, and Guatemala.

Despite initial concerns, the US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) later clarified that tsunami waves were not expected to reach the US Atlantic or Gulf Coast. However, small sea-level changes were still anticipated. In particular, a tsunami wave of between The US government monitor later canceled most of its initial tsunami warnings but maintained alerts for three countries, including Cuba, Honduras, and the Cayman Islands. In light of the warnings, several Caribbean nations took precautionary measures, urging residents in coastal areas to evacuate. Honduras, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, and the Cayman Islands issued evacuation orders for their citizens near the coastlines. The Cayman Islands government advised its residents in coastal areas to move inland to safer locations.

The earthquake and its aftershocks sent shockwaves throughout the region, and the earthquake's sudden impact served as a reminder of the seismic activity in the Caribbean. Local governments and authorities in the affected areas remain on high alert as they monitor potential aftershocks and the possibility of further tsunami waves. Despite the cancellation of some tsunami alerts, residents are still urged to stay vigilant and follow evacuation instructions to ensure safety.



### Monsters: Netanyahu Vows To 'Eliminate' Hamas Amid Ceasefire Deal

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has pledged to destroy Hamas and secure the release of all Israeli captives held by the Palestinian militant group, following a fifth hostage exchange on Saturday. The exchange, which took place under a ceasefire agreement in Gaza, saw the release of three hostages who appeared visibly emaciated and were forced to speak on stage after being handed over by Hamas.

In a video statement, Netanyahu condemned Hamas as "monsters" and emphasized Israel's unwavering commitment to dismantling the group. "We will eliminate Hamas, and we will return our hostages," Netanyahu stated, reinforcing his government's resolve in the ongoing conflict. The handover of the three hostages marked a momentary pause in the conflict, but Netanyahu's rhetoric indicated that Israel's operations to neutralize Hamas would continue.

The recent hostage exchange was part of a broader ceasefire agreement aimed at de-escalating violence in Gaza. While the exchange provided some relief to the families of the hostages, the images of the captives — visibly weakened after their ordeal — underscored the brutal conditions they had endured. Their forced appearance on stage further highlighted the psychological and physical toll taken by their months in captivity.

Israel has long viewed Hamas as a significant threat, and Netanyahu's government has been adamant about its commitment to eradicating the group, which it holds responsible for the deaths of countless Israelis in previous conflicts. The Israeli military has launched multiple operations aimed at weakening Hamas's military capabilities, though the group has continued to launch attacks against Israel, fueling the ongoing cycle of violence.

As India grows more cautious about Chinese investments in sensitive

sectors, due to ongoing border disputes and economic tensions, the country is increasingly seeking trade partnerships with other regions. While India's trade growth with Western economies remains strong, China's trade with the US and EU is expected to slow. In response, China is focusing on strengthening economic ties with India, Russia, ASE-AN, Africa, and Mercosur nations. However, China's trade surpluses may face resistance from India and its other trade partners.

Corporate earnings will play a crucial role in shaping market sentiment. Key companies such as Eicher Motors, Apollo Hospitals, Vodafone Idea, Hindustan Aeronautics, and Muthoot Finance are set to report their quarterly results. In a statement on social media, Sindhu explained that she felt a twinge in her hamstring during training in Guwahati on February 4. Despite trying to push through with heavy taping, an MRI revealed that her recovery would take longer than anticipated.

Sindhu has been battling injuries since claiming her first women's singles gold at the 2022 Commonwealth Games. A left foot stress fracture during the event sidelined her for the remainder of the year, missing the World Championships and World Tour Finals.

India, placed in a tough Group D alongside South Korea and Macau, will begin their campaign on February 12 against Macau, followed by a challenging match against South Korea on February 13. Sindhu expressed her support for the team, stating that she would be "cheering from the sidelines."

Taryana captain Ankit Kumar's Hbrilliant century put his team in a strong position against defending champions Mumbai on the second day of their Ranji Trophy quarter-final. Ankit's 136 runs guided Haryana to 263/5, closing in on Mumbai's first-innings total of 315. Despite Tanush Kotian's valiant 97 for Mumbai, Haryana's dominant performance with the bat left them just 53 runs behind,

with Ankit leading from the front and punishing the bowlers.

In contrast, Tamil Nadu's batting woes continued against Vidarbha. 
