CM Naidu Inaugurates International Temples Convention and Expo at Tirupati

CM Chandrababu Naidu inaugurated the International Temples Convention and Expo in Tirupati, addressing the crowd with his vision for India's future. Praising the leadership of the Prime Minister, he expressed that India's technological progress is leaps and bounds ahead, particularly benefiting from the nation's large youth population. He believes that India can reach the top global position by 2047. Chandrababu discussed the integration of technology in temple programs, making religious practices more accessible. He emphasized that serving God is paramount and mentioned how Tirumala Balaji symbolizes the trust of millions of devotees. Regarding temple development, he revealed that Rs. 134 crores had been allocated for infrastructure improvements in temples across Andhra Pradesh. Additionally, funds are being directed towards the salaries of priests and the development of Vedic schools. Committees for major temples are being established to organize programs effectively.

Highlighting the economic potential of temples, Chandrababu stated that they are not just spiritual centers but also key sources of income, particularly through temple tourism. He noted that large donations from devotees are being used for educa-

tional, medical, and social service programs.

The CM also spoke about efforts to improve the experience for devotees by enhancing facilities and increasing greenery in temples. He highlighted that efforts are underway to achieve 75 percent greenery in Tirumala. He stressed the importance of temples in preserving India's cultural heritage.

Chandrababu concluded by recalling the Annadanam program initiated by NTR, which now provides Anna Prasadam to lakhs of people daily. He also mentioned the growing number of Lord Venkateswara temples both in India and abroad, with plans to set up a temple circuit in the state.

The increasing spread of explicit and sensational content across social media platforms has sparked concerns over media ethics and censorship. With little to no regulation, digital platforms are becoming breeding grounds for inappropriate content, overshadowing the primary role of journalism.

Traditionally regarded as the fourth pillar of democracy, the media was expected to act as a watchdog and voice public concerns. However, with the rise of digital platforms, mainstream media has shifted its focus from responsible journalism to chasing sensational content. The demand for adult-themed debates and scandalous reports has overshadowed meaningful discourse. Conversations between individuals are being twisted into controversy, leading to explicit videos being uploaded across various channels.

YouTube, once considered an alternative for independent voices, has now become a battleground for sensationalism, bypassing traditional journalism with unchecked content. The increasing competition for views and revenue has resulted in unethical practices, including the invasion of celebrities' personal lives for TRPs.

A recent case involving Lavanya is a prime example of the media's reckless approach. Despite the case being unrelated to Shekhar Basha, several channels dragged him into their reports for the sake of increasing viewership. Lavanya was subjected to repeated interviews, and her call records were exposed on live television.

Similarly, the social media frenzy surrounding Duvvada and Madhuri's relationship highlights the exploitation of personal affairs for online engagement. The controversy, which started with Duvvada's issues with his wife Vani, was amplified by YouTube channels through interviews and exaggerated narratives. The relentless focus on their relationship was aimed purely at boosting channel traffic. Jana Sena leader Kiran Royal's leaked phone call further demonstrates how media outlets fabricate stories without verification. YouTube thumbnails have become more obscene than the content itself, with exaggerated imagery designed to mislead viewers. Despite these alarming trends, state I&PR departments remain passive, failing to take necessary action against misleading and inappropriate media

With thousands of YouTube channels emerging across Telugu states, concerns over media guidelines have intensified. While platform policies exist, enforcement remains weak. Governments have introduced laws regarding social media regulation, but their ineffective implementation has allowed unchecked content to thrive. Experts warn that if this trend continues, the media's role in society could become even more damaging in the future.

The urgent need for stricter guidelines and active enforcement is evident. Without proper regulation, the credibility of journalism will continue to erode, leading to a media landscape dominated by sensationalism and unethical practices.

of Prisons on CCTV Installation in

The Andhra Pradesh High Court has issued significant orders regarding the installation of CCTV cameras in police stations and prisons across the state. A petition was filed earlier regarding the issue, prompting the court to question the government about the installation and functionality of CCTV cameras. The High Court inquired whether CCTV cameras have been installed in all police stations and prisons, with a particular focus on ensuring comprehensive coverage of the premises. During the proceedings, the court revealed that, out of 1,392 police stations in the state, only 1,001 have CCTV cameras installed, while 81 prisons have 1,226 cameras, of which only 785 are operational.

In response to the concerns raised, the court directed the state government to examine these issues and submit a report to the senior IT officer in charge. Additionally, the court highlighted the need for footage backup systems, in line with Supreme Court guidelines requiring the preservation of CCTV footage for at least 12 months.

The High Court has now mandated that the DGP and DG of Prisons file separate affidavits with complete details regarding the installation, maintenance, and backup of CCTV footage.



No Need to Worry About GBS Disease, Minister **Kolusu Parthasarathy Assures Public TPN Correspondent** Eluru, Feb 18

State Housing, Information, and Public Relations Minister Kolusu Parthasarathy reassured the public about GBS (Guillain-Barré Syndrome) and emphasized that there is no need for panic. During a meeting with medical officers, he urged them to remove misconceptions about the disease and make emergency medicines and immunoglobulin injections available in all government hospitals across Eluru district. The Minister explained that GBS typically subsides on its own, starting in the legs and progressing to the upper body. He advised the public to maintain proper hygiene and visit a government hospital if they experience symptoms such as cramps or difficulty walk-

Minister Parthasarathy also called for insulin injections for diabetes patients, factor injections for hemophilia patients, and a supply of Tenecteplase injections for heart disease patients to be stocked in all hospitals. These life-saving medications, which are often too expensive for the poor, should be made available at government facilities. He also emphasized the importance of creating awareness, as GBS cases are being reported in other districts.

Minister Nara Lokesh and Wife Participate in Holy Dips at Mahakumbh Mela

AP Minister Nara Lokesh, alongside his wife Brahmini, took part in the Mahakumbh Mela in Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh, by taking a traditional holy dip at the Triveni Sangam. The couple performed rituals at the sacred site, worshipping Goddess Ganga and offering aarti. They also paid tribute to their ancestral gods by offering clothes to the Brahmins and prayed for the salvation of their ancestors.

The Mahakumbh Mela, ongoing since January 13 and concluding on February 26, has seen a massive turnout of devotees. Crores of people, including Prime Minister Modi, VIPs, and common citizens, have participated in the spiritual event.

Nara Lokesh and his wife, fully immersed in the spiritual environment of the Kumbh, joined in the kirtans and pujas, reflecting the deep cultural and spiritual significance of the Mela. The event is considered a symbol of India's heritage, where millions believe bathing in the holy rivers and offering devotion leads to salvation. After their visit to the Triveni Sangam, the couple continued their spiritual journey by visiting the Kashi Vishweshwara temple in Varanasi. The Uttar Pradesh government has reported that a record 50 crore devotees have bathed at the Sangam, making this year's Mahakumbh Mela the largest spiritual gathering in history.

No Need to Worry About Guillain-Barré **Syndrome: Minister Satyakumar**

AP Health Minister Satyakumar Yadav has reassured the public, stating there is no need to worry about Guillain-Barré Syndrome (GBS). Addressing concerns in a media conference with health department officials, the Minister highlighted the effective treatment measures in place and assured the public of sufficient resources to

The Minister confirmed that 43 GBS cases have been registered in the state, with 17 patients currently receiving treatment. He emphasized that the disease often resolves on its own without requiring treatment, with 85% of those infected recovering naturally. Only 15% of cases require immunoglobulin injections.

In a bid to reassure the public, Satyakumar announced that the state has a sufficient stock of immunoglobulin injections, which are being distributed across various government hospitals. Currently, 749 injections are available at hospitals in Anantapur, Guntur, Kadapa, Kakinada, Rajahmundry, and Visakhapatnam, with an additional 469 injections in reserve for distribution as needed.

On Monday, the court received two separate petitions and ordered that notices be issued to both parties, adjourning the case to Febru-

The police filed a petition seeking Vamsi's custody for ten days in connection with the Satyavardhan kidnapping case. Simultaneously, Vamsi's legal team submitted a request for permission to allow him to receive home-cooked food and a bed, citing health concerns. The court is set to hear both matters in its next session, with both sides preparing for what could be a decisive hearing.

Meanwhile, a significant development unfolded as Satyavardhan's statement was officially recorded in the Second Junior Civil Judge's court in Vijayawada. The statement, captured on video in the presence of Magistrate Appa Rao, is expected to be a critical piece of evidence.

The Patamata police, who had previously interrogated Satyavardhan, revealed serious allegations that Vamsi and his associates had pressured him to withdraw his complaints related to the 2023 attack on the Gannavaram TDP office. According to reports, Satyavardhan's family members were also threatened during this period, raising concerns about witness safety and the extent of intimidation tactics.

Following the interrogation, Satyavardhan was brought before the magistrate to officially record his testimony. His detailed statement is likely to influence the course of the investigation, as authorities look into the accusations of coercion and the broader circumstances surrounding the TDP office attack.

The court's upcoming session is expected to address both the police's demand for extended custody of Vamsi and the defense's plea for health-related accommodations, setting the stage for a pivotal moment in this high-profile case.

AP JAC Amaravati Urges Govt to Address Village Secretariat Employee Concerns

A key meeting was held with village ward secretariat employee associations to discuss pressing issues regarding their service matters. The meeting, chaired by the concerned departmental secretary, focused on resolving the challenges faced by secretariat employees, particularly in the wake of recent changes to the system. APJAC Amaravati State Chairman Bopparaju Venkateswarlu, along with leaders of various associations, submitted a letter to the government highlighting the difficulties faced by employees. They requested clear categorization of employees under the Multi-Purpose Functionaries, Technical, and Aspirational Functionaries as detailed in the rationalization pro-



One of the major requests was for additional secretariat staff in areas with populations exceeding 3501. The leaders recommended appointing one additional employee for every 500-1000 people above this threshold to ensure manageable workloads. They also sought clarity on the status of the newly introduced Aspiration Functionaries and their alignment with the Aspiration Blocks and Districts program.

The meeting also addressed concerns regarding the Junior Assistant pay scale, which the employees felt would not impose an additional financial burden on the government. They appealed for all employees to be considered for this scale, highlighting the need for fairness.

Furthermore, leaders raised concerns about the discrepancy in salary allowances based on the 11th PRC and called for adjustments in the upcoming 12th PRC. The employees also stressed the need for promotions, as many had been waiting for career advancement since their initial appointments.

Corruption Allegations Rock Vijayawada Municipal Corporation

The Vijayawada Municipal Corporation (VMC) has once again come under scrutiny over serious corruption allegations. Following accusations against Biologist Suryakumar in the Malaria Department, fresh claims have emerged against CMHO officials and supervisors, raising concerns over their alleged involvement in illegal activities. The recent fire accident at the Kashmir Jalakanya exhibition has further exposed the extent of the corruption within the municipal body.

On Wednesday at noon, a massive fire broke out at the Kashmir Jalakanya exhibition, reportedly caused by a short circuit that ignited gas cylinders. While initial discussions centered on the cause of the fire, the real issue—the exhibition's lack of proper permissions—came to light later. Despite applying for a trade license, the exhibition organizers failed to secure official approval. Allegations suggest that the event was allowed to operate under the influence of corrupt VMC officials.

The Kashmir Jalakanya exhibition is managed by three individuals—Raja Reddy, Adapa Prabhakar, and Vijay. It is alleged that Adapa Prabhakar, responsible for securing permissions, colluded with VMC officials and fire safety personnel to run the event



without proper clearance. Reports indicate that CMHO Supervisor Shivaram Prasad and Worker Shankar played a key role in this corruption, allegedly collecting a bribe of ₹5 lakh from the exhibition organizers to overlook the lack of permissions.

Fortunately, the fire accident resulted in no major casualties as it occurred during the daytime when foot traffic was low. However, had it happened in the evening, the

consequences could have been disas-

Despite clear evidence of corruption, the VMC Commissioner has only is-

sued show cause notices to the Fire Department, rather than taking strict action against CMHO officials. This raises serious concerns about the administration's accountability. Additionally, the fire incident has exposed a larger issue how many other businesses in Vijayawada are operating without valid trade licenses? With mounting allegations and public outcry, demands for a thorough investigation into VMC's operations are

growing. The lack of transparency and regulatory oversight in the municipal administration has once again put the safety and trust of the citizens at risk.

Panchayat Champions Should Focus on Village Development: MP Kesineni Shivnath

Chintamohan Criticizes BJP and Andhra Pradesh Governance

In a press conference, Chintamohan, former Union Minister and senior Congress Party leader, sharply criticized several issues plaguing both the national and state government. He first condemned the BJP for using temples and religious events for financial gains, specifically targeting the involvement of BJP Chief Ministers in conferences organized around world temples. He expressed concerns over attempts to grant sanitation contracts to a Bombay-based company in the name of temple events, calling it unethical.

Further, Chintamohan voiced strong objections to Prime Minister Modi's recent visit to the United States, alleging that the trip was primarily to help Adani's case in America. He claimed that the government's efforts were aimed at tampering with legal proceedings, which, according

to him, could damage India's integrity on the international stage.

The former minister also commented on the state of governance in Andhra Pradesh, criticizing the lack of security for female students in Anantapur, where students were forced to use ladders to go to bathrooms. He also highlighted the dire conditions for farmers in the state, including the unfair prices for Guntur chili, Rayalaseema tomatoes, and rice, accusing the government of failing to fulfill promises made to farmers.

Chintamohan concluded by criticizing the coalition government in Andhra Pradesh for neglecting backward areas and failing to provide adequate funds to improve conditions in rural districts. He also expressed disappointment with Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu's failure to set up an inquiry commission regarding the alleged misuse of funds in Polavaram.



Strict Biosecurity Measures and Surveillance Enforced in Bird Flu Buffer Zone - Dist Collector

In light of confirmed bird flu cases following the deaths of chickens in Anumallanka, Gampalagudem mandal, District Collector Dr. G. Lakshmi Sha has emphasized the need for continued alertness and rigorous control measures in 35 villages within a 10-kilometer radius. In a meeting held at the Collectorate, Dr. Lakshmi Sha reviewed ongoing efforts to prevent the out. Dr. Lakshmi Sha also instructed spread of avian influenza, confirmed by the National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD) on February 14.

The Collector stressed the importance of biosecurity protocols, directing officials to ensure that chicken and egg shops in the buffer zone remain closed until further notice. Extensive sanitation programs, including the use of sprayers and foggers, are being carried



continuous 24X7 monitoring at all 116 poultry farms in the district to ensure compliance with biosecurity mea-

Revenue staff and panchayat secretaries have been urged to stay alert at the field level, while fever surveys and testing of samples in the buffer zone are being conducted to track any health impacts. The Collector reassured the public that there is no immediate cause for concern but emphasized the importance of vigilance and proper procedures.

The meeting was attended by key officials, including District Animal Husbandry Officer Dr. M. Hanumantha Rao and DMHO Dr. M. Suhasini, who are actively involved in the coordinated response. Forest officials were also instructed to report any unnatural bird deaths immediately.

Alleged Medical Negligence at Vijayawada Govt Hospital Leads to Patient's Death

In a shocking incident at Vijayawada Government Hospital, a young woman, Sunitha, from Kandurlapadu, G Konduru mandal, tragically passed away after receiving a series of injections to control her sugar levels. Sunitha had been rushed to the hospital due to elevated sugar levels, and doctors administered an injection at 12 noon to regulate her condition. However, shortly after another injection was given later in the evening,

she fell unconscious and died within minutes.

The relatives of the deceased are now protesting at the hospital, alleging medical malpractice and negligence by government doctors. They claim Sunitha, a woman under 30 years of age, died due to improper

treatment. The family is demanding accountability and justice for her untimely death, questioning the medical procedures followed at the hospital.

This tragic incident has raised serious concerns about the quality of healthcare and the protocols followed in government hospitals. The family's grief is compounded by their belief that the doctors' actions directly contributed to their loved one's death, sparking protests and calls for action against those responsible.

Sand Mining Without Permits: NGT Orders ₹25 Crore Fine on Telangana Mining & Irrigation Departments

The National Green Tribunal (NGT) in Chennai has delivered a landmark verdict, imposing a fine of Rs 25 crore each on Telangana's Mining and Irrigation departments for conducting sand mining without environmental permits in the Maneru River. This ruling, made by the NGT South Bench, has drawn significant attention as it underscores the importance of environmental clearance for sand mining activ-

The case pertains to illegal sand mining in the Maneru River, flowing through Peddapalli, Karimnagar, and Jayashankar districts. Environmental groups, including the Maneru Conservation Committee. filed multiple petitions in the NGT, arguing that mining activities were causing severe ecological damage and depleting groundwater resources. Despite interim orders to halt mining, the authorities continued operations, prompting the tribunal's stringent order.

The NGT's verdict has raised concerns

about the increasing environmental damage from illegal sand mining. Excessive mining with heavy machinery is not only damaging the riverbed but also disrupting local communities, causing road destruction, health issues, and major accidents. The tribunal's decision emphasizes the need for stringent environmental regulations to protect natural resources.

The ruling serves as a stern reminder for the Telangana government, which has been under scrutiny for its role in sanctioning sand mining projects across various rivers in the state. As the mining activities intensify, the government faces growing opposition from environmental groups and locals urging for the cessation of these harmful practices. The coalition government's actions, along with the disregard for proper permits, have raised questions about the future of sand mining in the region.

However, the party could not agree on a suitable replacement, leading to the imposition of President's Rule. Critics argue that this move is an attempt to divert attention from the BJP's failures in handling the crisis and the suffering of the people of Manipur.

For true accountability and a resolution to the crisis, a Joint Parliamentary Committee should be formed to thoroughly examine the multiple dimensions of the Manipur tragedy. Only through this process, rather than the political expediency of President's Rule, can justice be delivered to the people of Manipur.

In addition to people-to-people ties, Qatar is a reliable supplier of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) to India. This energy partnership has been central to the relationship, providing India with affordable and stable energy. However, with India diversifying its energy sources, especially increasing imports from the United States, questions arise about Qatar's future role in India's energy landscape. While the

country remains an important partner, India must navigate this evolving energy dynamic cautiously, mindful of not taking Qatar's generosity for granted.

Furthermore, India's engagement with Qatar goes beyond trade and energy. The resolution of the diplomatic crisis involving eight former Indian Navy officials, sentenced to death in Qatar, demonstrated India's strategic leverage. Prime Minister Modi's personal intervention underscored the importance of high-level diplomatic relations with Qatar, which also signed long-term LNG deals with India despite the European gas scramble.

As India strengthens its ties with the broader GCC region, Qatar's strategic importance remains paramount. With the focus shifting to emerging sectors like renewable energy, fintech, and infrastructure, India's relationship with Qatar will likely continue to evolve beyond traditional energy partnerships. However, challenges such as regional instability, labor rights issues, and tensions in the Israel-Hamas conflict require ongoing, nuanced dialogue. In conclusion, India-Qatar relations are increasingly complex, intertwined with energy security, regional geopolitics, and economic collaboration. As India's influence in the Gulf grows, it must continue to nurture this critical relationship with Qatar, ensuring mutual benefits while addressing regional and global challenges.

New Delhi Station Stampede Highlights Urgent **Need for Railway Modernization**

On February 15, 2025, a tragic stampede at New Delhi Railway Station claimed the lives of at least 18 people and injured many others. This incident has once again brought attention to the perennial problem of overcrowding at the station, which, despite being the busiest in India, continues to operate at outdated capacity levels. While the standard rituals—condolences from the government, compensation for the victims, and the announcement of a high-level inquiry have been swiftly completed, the underlying issue remains unaddressed: the lack of modern infrastructure at one of the most critical transport hubs in the country.

The Growing Traffic Surge and Its Risks

New Delhi station is not just the busiest station in India; it generates the highest passenger revenue, accounting for over Rs 3,337 crore in 2023-24. However, the station's infrastructure, which opened in 1955, has not been upgraded to handle the ever-growing number of passengers. Officially, the station's capacity reached its limit by 2000, with daily traffic hovering around 500,000 passengers. This is in stark contrast to the current numbers, where the station regularly handles between 7 to 8 lakh passengers during peak seasons, causing congestion that can turn hazardous in a heartbeat.

Despite the seasonal surge in passenger traffic being predictable, Indian Railways (IR) continues to rely on rudimentary measures to manage this influx. As the recent stampede tragically demonstrated, the lack of adequate infrastructure to handle surges leaves passengers vulnerable, and this vulnerability will only increase as the number of rail users continues to rise.

A Long Delayed Modernization Plan

The need for New Delhi station's modernization has been apparent for over two decades. The first attempt to modernize the station was conceived in the early 2000s, around the same time as the modernization of Delhi's international airport. In 2007, a design was finalized by the renowned architecture firm Farrells, with the plan to increase station capacity, improve amenities, and create a new urban space above the railway tracks. Despite this ambitious plan, it never came to fruition due to delays, opposition from local authorities, and failed tenders.

The first failed attempt came in 2008, with confusion surrounding tender clauses, followed by another cancellation in 2009 due to bureaucratic



hurdles. A third attempt in 2022 saw a scaledback version of the original plan, but that, too, failed when the winning bidder, L&T, quoted over Rs 8,000 crore, exceeding the government's estimate of Rs 5,000 crore.

In 2023, Indian Railways reduced the scope of work further and attempted to launch the project on a smaller scale, yet the tender was withdrawn in early 2024. The Rail Land Development Authority (RLDA) has since fragmented the project into smaller tenders in hopes of attracting more bidders, but as of now, the modernization effort remains stalled.

Effective Measures to Prevent Future Accidents

While the tragic stampede at New Delhi Station highlights the urgency of modernization, it is also a reminder that such incidents can be prevented with the right measures. Here are some strategies that can be adopted to manage the surge in passenger traffic:

Optimizing Platform Capacity: This involves increasing the number of platforms and utilizing space more efficiently to accommodate more trains and passengers.

- Technology-Based Solutions: Implementing smart ticketing systems, AI-based crowd management tools, and real-time passenger flow tracking can help manage congestion.
- Improved Signage and Barriers: Clear and visible signage to direct passenger movement can reduce chaos, especially during peak hours. Barriers can be used to separate different streams of passenger flow.
- Adequate Staffing: Adequate staff presence at critical locations, including ticket counters, platforms, and gates, is essential for maintaining order and directing passengers effectively.
- Coordination with Train Schedules: Well-coordinated train schedules during peak times can reduce overcrowding on platforms and in trains.
- Crowd Control Measures: Barriers, ropes, and entry/exit points should be designed to channel passengers in a way that prevents overcrowding, especially at entry and exit points.
- **Emergency Preparedness: Stations should** have well-established emergency re-

sponse protocols, with staff trained to handle crises efficiently.

Infrastructure Upgrades: Finally, upgrading station infrastructure to handle the increased traffic and to provide adequate facilities for passengers is key to preventing such accidents.

New Delhi Railway Station stands as a symbol of India's growth in terms of rail passenger traffic, but its outdated infrastructure is a stark reminder of how critical modernization efforts can be in preventing avoidable tragedies. As the busiest station in the country, it is inconceivable that New Delhi Railway Station is still grappling with capacity issues, especially when its modernization plan has been on the table for over 20 years. The failure of successive efforts to upgrade the station is a reflection of the inefficiencies within Indian Railways, and the recent stampede should serve as a wake-up call for both the government and the railway authorities. If such accidents are to be avoided in the future, New Delhi Station's modernization needs to move beyond planning stages into actionable, urgent steps—before another tragedy strikes.



India Can Turn "Fast Fashion" Waste Into Opportunity: PM Modi At Bharat Tex 2025

Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed the gathering at Bharat Tex 2025 on Sunday evening, emphasizing the need for India's textile industry to turn the challenge of "fast fashion waste" into an opportunity. He highlighted the importance of maximizing resource use and minimizing waste generation in the sector. The Prime Minister pointed out that millions of garments are discarded each month due to changing fashion trends, creating significant environmental concerns. He also noted that by 2030, fashion waste could reach 148 million tons, with less than a quarter currently being recycled.

PM Modi suggested that India's rich traditional skills in textile

address this issue. He cited examples from Maharashtra, where old fabrics are transformed into mats, rugs, and quilts. The Prime Minister encouraged innovation in these practices, which could help tap into global market opportunities. He announced that the Textile Ministry had signed an MoU with the Standing Conference of Public Enterprises and e-Marketplace to promote upcycling, with several up-cyclers already registered.

PM Modi projected that India's textile recycling market could grow to USD 400 million in the next few years, while the global recycled textile market is expected to reach USD 7.5 billion. He expressed confidence that India could capture a larger share of this market.

Reflecting on India's prosperous past, where the textile industry played a crucial role, the Prime Minister reiterated that as the country strives towards becoming a Viksit Bharat, the textile sector would again be pivotal. He lauded Bharat Tex as a strong platform for global engagement, collaboration, and partnership, with over 120 countries participating in the event.

He also urged the banking sector to support textile entrepreneurs, fostering business growth and job creation. Bharat Tex 2025, held at Bharat Mandapam from February 14-17, is one of the largest events of its kind, showcasing the entire textile ecosystem and providing a platform for innovation and collaboration.

Gyanesh Kumar Likely to Become India's Next Chief Election Commissioner

Gyanesh Kumar, who was appointed as an Election Commissioner in March of last year, is set to replace Rajiv Kumar as the Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) of India, sources told NDTV on Monday evening. If confirmed, Mr. Kumar will oversee the conduct of several crucial elections, including the Bihar Assembly election later this year, as well as elections in Bengal, Assam, and Tamil Nadu next year.

Mr. Kumar, a 1988-batch IAS officer from the Kerala cadre, is currently the senior-most commissioner on the three-member Election Commission panel, which was previously led by Rajiv Kumar. The other commissioner on the panel is Sukhbir Singh Sandhu from the Uttarakhand cadre. However, Mr. Kumar's appointment has yet to be formally ratified.

The Congress party has raised objections to the swift move to appoint a new CEC, pointing out that the Supreme Court is set to hear a challenge to the 2023 law that governs the selection process. Critics of the law argue that it allows the ruling BJP to have control over the CEC appointment, with the process being decided by a three-member panel consisting of the Prime Minister, the Home Minister, and the Leader of the Opposition.

Mr. Kumar, 61, has held several key positions in the Indian civil services. Prior to his appointment as Election Commissioner, he was part of the Union Home Ministry, where he played a crucial role in drafting the bill that scrapped Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir in 2019. He was also responsible for handling key documents related to the Supreme Court case on the Ram Temple in Ayodhya. Additionally, he is known to have a close rela-

tionship with Home Minister Amit Shah.

Before retiring in January last year, Mr. Kumar served as the Secretary of the Ministry of Cooperation, a position also overseen by Amit Shah. He has previously held roles in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs and the Defence Ministry during the Congress-led UPA government. Mr. Kumar holds a B.Tech in Civil Engineering from the Indian Institute of Engineering in Kanpur, along with degrees in Business Finance and Environmental Economics from the Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India and Harvard University, respectively.

Rajiv Kumar, the outgoing Chief Election Commissioner, stepped down this morning after a tenure marked by efforts to modernize the election process. In his farewell speech, Mr. Kumar emphasized the importance of innovations such as remote voting for NRIs and migrant workers, biometric voting systems, and safeguarding against postpoll violence by ensuring the non-disclosure of votes. He also highlighted the need for greater financial transparency in election campaign expenses and the growing role of Artificial Intelligence in the future of elections



To Ban or Not to Ban: Alcohol Divides J&K's Political Landscape

The ruling National Conference (NC) in Jammu and Kashmir is facing significant criticism for its change of stance on the issue of liquor sales in the region. The NC's volte-face has sparked a backlash, especially from political and religious figures, as well as civil society groups. The controversy revolves around the Bills to be introduced in the upcoming assembly session, which seek to ban the sale and consumption of liquor in Jammu and Kashmir.

Mirwaiz Umar Farooq, the chairman of the Moderate Hurriyat, condemned NC leader Tanvir Sadiq's defense of liquor sales, which he justified under the pretext of boosting tourism. Mirwaiz, speaking at an interfaith event in Budgam district on February 16, questioned the morality of such a move in a Muslim-majority region, emphasizing the harm caused to society by drug abuse. He criticized the NC for ignoring the example of other Indian states, such as Gujarat, where alcohol is banned and tourism continues to thrive.

Sadiq had earlier argued that liquor sales should be allowed to support tourism, noting that several countries in the Arab world permit alcohol for tourists. He insisted that the local stakeholders, including travel agents, should be consulted before taking any drastic steps.

However, Mirwaiz dismissed this argument, pointing out that no consultation had been held with the stakeholders of Jammu and Kashmir regarding the issue. Opposition parties, including the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP), also expressed their disapproval, arguing that linking tourism to alcohol sales is flawed. PDP leader Waheed Parra pointed to Gujarat's success as a dry state, where tourism has flourished without the need for liquor sales.

In the upcoming legislative session, at least three private member Bills will be introduced, seeking a ban on alcohol in Jammu and Kashmir. These Bills have garnered support from various quarters, including BJP leader Darakhshan Andrabi, who welcomed the move as a step toward protecting the youth from drug abuse.

The ongoing debate reflects the deepening divide over the future of alcohol sales in Jammu and Kashmir, with strong opinions from both sides of the political spectrum.

CM Stalin Slam Pradhan For Forcing Tamil Nadu to Adopt Three-Language Formula


Tamil Nadu Chief Minister M.K. Stalin has accused Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan of "blackmail" after the latter stated that Tamil Nadu would not receive funds under the Samagra Shiksha Abhiyaan unless it accepts the National Education Policy (NEP) and the controversial three-language formula. Stalin expressed his displeasure over Pradhan's comments, asserting that Tamil Nadu's rightful due for educational funds should not be contingent on political conditions.

Stalin posted a video of Pradhan speaking on social media, stating that the Union Minister's remarks were disrespectful and threatening, warning that Tamil Nadu might show Delhi the "real trait" of its people in response. The Chief Minister's comment resonated with opposition parties across Tamil Nadu, who strongly criticized the Union government's stance on this issue.

Edappadi K. Palaniswami, General Secretary of AIADMK and Leader of the Opposition in Tamil Nadu, also condemned the central government's decision. He remarked that the Centre's refusal to release funds based on Tamil Nadu's rejection of the three-language policy was unjust. Palaniswami emphasized that Tamil Nadu had been a pioneer in the field of education and that the Centre should focus on the welfare of the people, not the political leaders in power.

The stance was echoed by Seeman, the chief of the Naam Tamilar Katchi (NTK), who criticized the NEP's push to make Hindi mandatory. He argued that while the people of Tamil Nadu could choose to learn Hindi, the Centre should not impose the language on them. Seeman expressed that India's unity lies in its linguistic diversity and that Tamil Nadu's opposition to the NEP should not result in withholding educational funds.

The controversy highlights the growing tensions between the state and central governments over educational policies, with Tamil Nadu leaders continuing to reject the imposition of Hindi and the three-language policy.



Assam CM Orders Probe into Alleged Pakistani Links of Gaurav Gogoi's Wife

Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma has ordered a case against a Pakistani national, Ali Tauqeer Sheikh, for allegedly attempting to interfere in domestic matters in Assam and India. Sarma also revealed that Elizabeth Colburn, the wife of Congress MP Gaurav Gogoi, will be investigated for her alleged ties to Pakistan and its intelligence agency, ISI.

Sarma's decision came after a cabinet meeting on Sunday, where he cited reports of Sheikh's online activities and his connections with Colburn. According to Sarma, Sheikh, who founded LEAD Pakistan, a non-profit organization focused on climate change, has had direct contact with Colburn, who was involved with the organization during her time in Islamabad. Both Sheikh and Colburn were part of the global climate action group, the Climate and Development Knowledge Network (CDKN), which operates in both India and Pakintan

Sarma raised concerns over the national security implications of the situation, particularly given Assam's historical vulnerabilities to destabilization by Pakistani actors. The Chief Minister also pointed out that Colburn, a British citizen, allegedly campaigned for Gogoi during two Lok Sabha elections, which would be a violation of visa norms. Sarma questioned the appropriateness of a foreign national participating in Indian elections, especially given her potential involvement in sensitive issues raised by her husband in Parliament, including nuclear radars and uranium mines.

Gaurav Gogoi, in response, dismissed the accusations as "dirty and baseless" politics and rejected the charges as "laughable and entertaining." He stated that his focus remains on improving Assam's economy, education, and healthcare policies, and expressed frustration with the ongoing political drama.

Sarma has called for a thorough investigation, involving central agencies, into the allegations against Colburn and Sheikh, stressing the importance of national security. He plans to share all relevant documents with Congress leaders to verify the facts.



Myanmar frees 1,000 scam center workers as crackdown widens


Myanmar's military government announced it is ready to hand over around 1,000 foreign nationals who were rescued from cyber scam centers near the Thai border. The victims, mostly from Asia and East Africa, were trafficked or tricked into working at these illicit centers. Myanmar authorities have vowed to intensify efforts to combat transnational criminal groups responsible for the operations.

Over the past three weeks, approximately 1,030 foreign nationals have been rescued from these scam centers, which are believed to be involved in online fraud. The Myanmar government has already repatriated 61 of the victims to their home countries, while the remaining individuals are set to be returned in the coming days, according to a statement from the State Administration Council, Myanmar's ruling military body.

The majority of the victims come from Asian countries, including China and India, although some are from East Africa. The victims were reportedly coerced or deceived into participating in online scams, where they were forced to defraud people across the globe. Many of the centers were located near the border with Thailand, a region notorious for transnational human trafficking and cybercrime activities.

The military junta launched a large-scale operation to combat online scams and human trafficking following mounting pressure from neighboring countries like Thailand and China. The high-profile trafficking of a Chinese actor, which highlighted the scale of criminal activities in the region, spurred Myanmar to take action.

The recent operation is part of a broader effort to dismantle criminal networks operating across Myanmar's borders. The government has promised to continue its crackdown on these illegal operations, although human rights organizations have raised concerns about the safety and treatment of the victims during the rescue and repatriation process. Myanmar's actions come amid growing regional concerns over the rise of cybercrime and human trafficking in Southeast Asia.

Income tax relief should not be seen as govt shifting focus from capex: Sitharaman

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Monday clarified that the substantial income tax relief announced in Budget 2025 does not signal a shift in the government's focus from capital expenditure to boosting consumption. This clarification comes after debates emerged over the decision to keep individuals earning up to Rs 12 lakh annually out of the income tax net, particularly following tepid GDP growth figures over two consecutive quarters.

During a post-budget interaction with stakeholders in Mumbai, Sitharaman emphasized that the government's commitment to capital expenditure (capex)

remains strong. She noted that the allocation for capex in the 2025 Budget is over 10.2% higher than last year, amounting to approximately Rs 16 lakh crore, including Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs). The central government alone has budgeted Rs 11.21 lakh crore for capex in 2025-26. The effective capital expenditure, which includes core capital outlays and grants for



state capital assets, is projected to rise to Rs 15.48 lakh crore from Rs 13.18 lakh crore in 2024-25.

Sitharaman dismissed concerns that the focus had shifted to consumption, stating that the government's emphasis has consistently been on public expenditure to build capital assets, especially since the COVID-19 pandemic. She reassured stake-

holders that the increased tax relief, which primarily benefits middle-class taxpayers, is aimed at enhancing disposable income for consumption and investment, not at sidelining the capital expenditure

The income tax relief, which raises the exemption limit from Rs 7 lakh to Rs 12 lakh, was positioned as part of the government's strategy to support economic recovery. Sitharaman also credited Prime Minister Narendra Modi for supporting the tax relief proposal, recognizing the need to reward taxpayers while main-

taining the focus on infrastructure development.

In conclusion, Sitharaman reiterated that the government's approach remains balanced, with continued investment in capital assets and targeted tax relief to stimulate consumption, creating a strong foundation for future economic growth.

Broader Impact Of Bitcoin On Global Economy



Bitcoin's emergence in 2008, closely following the global economic crisis, marked the beginning of a transformative journey in the world of finance. 

China Names Its Moon Spacesuit and Rover Ahead of Lunar Mission



hina has officially unveiled the unames for its next-generation lunar spacesuit and crewed moon rover, key components for its planned human moon landing before 2030. The China Manned Space Agency (CMSA) revealed that the spacesuit will be called "Wangyu," meaning "gazing into the cosmos," while the rover has been named "Tansuo," which translates to "explore." Over 9,000 suggestions were submitted during a public participation process in 2024, culminating in the final selection of these names.

The spacesuit, Wangyu, is designed to withstand the harsh conditions of the moon's surface, providing astronauts with enhanced mobility and protection. According to Zhang Wanxin, director of the spacesuit engineering office at the China Astronaut Research and Training Center, the prototype has already been developed, and performance assessments are currently underway to ensure it meets the required operational standards.

The Tansuo rover, which will facilitate lunar surface exploration, is also pro-

gressing through its development phase. Zhang Chongfeng, a spacecraft designer at CMSA, revealed that the rover prototype has been tested in a simulated lunar surface environment. The rover is undergoing design refinements and engineering assessments to ensure its effectiveness in transporting astronauts across the moon's challenging terrain. China's lunar mission framework is taking shape as the nation aims to land astronauts on the moon before 2030. CMSA has made significant progress in the development of ground facilities for production and testing, and construction at the Wenchang Spacecraft Launch Site in Hainan is advancing. Additionally, CMSA announced the names of other mission components, including the crew spacecraft, "Mengzhou" ("Dream Vessel"), and the lunar lander, "Lanyue" ("Embracing the Moon").

This mission is part of China's broader space exploration goals, which include advancing technology and scientific research beyond low Earth orbit. With an integrated system of heavy-lift launch vehicles, crewed spacecraft, and lunar surface mobility solutions, China is taking significant steps toward its ambitious goal of establishing a human pres-

ence on the moon.

Chinese Zoo Paints Donkeys To Look Like Zebras, Leaves Netizens Annoyed



A Chinese zoo has come under scrutiny after it allegedly painted donkeys to pass them off as zebras in an attempt to attract more visitors. The stunt, which took place at a zoo in Zibo City, Shandong province, quickly backfired after keeneyed netizens recognized the creatures

for what they truly were—donkeys, not zebras.

The controversy began when a video went viral showing a zoo worker standing next to a donkey with black and white stripes across its body. However, the worker left the donkey's face untouched, which made it even more obvious that it was not a zebra. The attempt to disguise the donkey as a zebra was so poorly executed that online viewers immediately noticed the difference, sparking a wave of jokes and criticism across social media platforms.

In response to the growing uproar, representatives from the amusement park told Chinese media that the painted donkeys were part of a "marketing strategy." However, their explanation did little to quell the backlash, with many criticizing the zoo for trying to deceive visitors. The debacle has raised questions about the ethics of using such deceptive practices in animal exhibits. While the zoo's marketing attempt may have been intended to draw attention, it ultimately served as a reminder of the power of social media and the sharp eye of internet users. The incident also highlights the importance of authenticity in tourism, with visitors increasingly expecting transparency and honesty from attractions.

Despite the failed stunt, the story has given the zoo a fleeting moment of fame—though likely not the kind they had hoped for. Instead of gaining new visitors through their creativity, they have become the subject of ridicule and mockery online.

OpenAl Shifts Focus to GPT-5, **Cancels Standalone** o3 Al Model



OpenAI CEO Sam Altman recently announced that the company has decided not to release the highly anticipated o3 artificial intelligence (AI) model. Instead of launching the o3 model as planned, OpenAI will now focus on a unified GPT-5 model, which will integrate the capabilities of o3.

Altman shared details about the company's updated AI roadmap, revealing that OpenAI will simplify its product offerings with the release of GPT-4.5 and GPT-5. The goal is to eliminate user confusion when choosing between various models for different tasks. Instead of offering multiple specialized models, GPT-5 will be designed to deliver "unified intelligence," meaning it will be capable of utilizing all OpenAI tools and know when to apply reasoning without users having to choose the appropriate model for each task.

The cancellation of the o3 model's standalone release marks the end of the o-series of AI models, with the company opting to integrate the features of o3 di-

rectly into GPT-5. Altman also announced changes to OpenAI's tiered subscription model. When GPT-5 is launched, all ChatGPT users will have access to the AI model, with free-tier users receiving unlimited chat access at the standard intelligence level. To prevent misuse, the company will impose abuse thresholds. Pro subscribers will get access to a higher intelligence level, and the top-tier subscribers will have the most advanced capabilities. GPT-5 will also introduce new

features, including Advanced Voice, Canvas, Search, and Deep Research. However, before GPT-5 arrives, OpenAI plans to launch GPT-4.5, its last non-chain-ofthought (non-CoT) model. While the exact release date is still unclear, Altman suggested that GPT-4.5 could arrive in the coming weeks or months. Interestingly, GPT-4.5, internally referred to as "Orion," was initially rumored to be GPT-5 itself.

With these developments, OpenAI is aiming to streamline its AI offerings and deliver a more efficient, user-friendly experience.

Apple Maps may soon include ads to boost services revenue



Apple Maps, which has long maintained an ad-free experience, is set to introduce ads on its platform. According to a Bloomberg report, the decision to integrate advertisements follows Apple's ongoing effort to enhance its services revenue. Business owners will soon have the opportunity to promote their locations within the app, a move that mirrors the advertising model used by Google Maps.

This shift in Apple Maps' strategy follows an internal all-hands meeting where the company's board gave the green light to explore the inclusion of ads. Although discussions around adding ads to Apple Maps have been ongoing since 2022, the rollout was initially expected in 2023 but was delayed for unspecified rea-

Apple Maps users, who have enjoyed an ad-free experience up until now, will soon encounter promoted listings for businesses, making it more similar to other mapping platforms like Google

Maps, which has long allowed businesses to pay for visibility in search results and map locations.

By introducing ads, Apple aims to diversify its services revenue, which has become an increasingly important part of the company's financial growth. As Apple continues to expand its advertising initiatives across its ecosystem, including the App Store and other apps, the move to include ads in Apple Maps marks another step in the company's broader strategy to increase earnings from services.

The exact timeline for the launch of ads on Apple Maps has not been confirmed, but business owners will soon be able to begin promoting their locations to potential customers directly through the platform. This change may offer new opportunities for businesses looking to increase their visibility within the app, while also contributing to Apple's overall revenue growth.
