A large-scale timber looting operation has come to light in Udayagiri constituency, Nellore district, where valuable Jamayal trees are being illegally cut down and transported. Allegations indicate that this deforestation is happening under the protection of influential figures within the udaygiri tdp MLA followers.

The lands in question belong to Agrigold, spanning thousands of acres and housing extensive Jamayal and mango plantations. However, reports suggest that certain groups, emboldened by their political connections, have been illegally harvesting timber and selling it for profit. Authorities had intervened in the past to deforestation has resumed, particularly in Varikuntapadu Mandal. Logs are reportedly being transported using lorries despite repeated complaints from local residents. Concerned over the authorities' lack

of action, CPI leaders and members accountable.

of the Agrigold Users and Agents' Welfare Association staged protests in front of the MRO office and police station. They accused officials of turning a blind eye to the ongoing looting and failing to take necessary action. Protesters also alleged that individuals who attempted to stop the illegal logging were attacked by ruling party supporters, raising fears of political interference in the issue. 



As the investigation into former Gannavaram MLA Vallabhaneni Vamsi's financial irregularities deepens, shocking revelations about his alleged financial dealings with women have emerged. The police have reportedly uncovered crores of rupees in transactions linked to a married air hostess and other women through electronic evidence.

According to sources, a married air hostess from Chintalapudi village in Gannavaram mandal, West Godavari district, is under scrutiny for amassing properties worth crores in a short period. Police investigations reveal that she owns a luxury apartment, villa, and two expensive cars in Hyderabad, and recently negotiated to buy a chartered flight. Further inquiries indicate that 15 acres of prime land were purchased near Chintalapudi and Jangareddygudem, along with a three-acre shopping complex in Eluru.



CM Naidu, Dy CM Pawan **Meets Union Minister CR Patil** to Discuss AP Projects

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan met Union Minister for Water Resources CR Patil in Delhi on Thursday to discuss key state development projects.

During the meeting, CM Chandrababu emphasized the urgent need for reimbursement of funds spent on the Polavaram left and right canal construction. He also requested Union assistance to expedite the completion of the Polavaram project.

CM Chandrababu presented the Po-

lavaram-Banakacharla Link Project, which proposes the transfer of 200 TMC floodwater from the Godavari at Polavaram to Banakacharla. He highlighted the project's benefits, stating that it would help make Andhra Pradesh drought-free, provide drinking water to 80 lakh people, and support agricultural expansion by creating a new ayacut of 3 lakh hectares while stabilizing 9.14 lakh hectares of existing farmland. Additionally, 20 TMC of water would be allocated to industries, boosting economic growth.

After the meeting, CM Chandrababu and Deputy CM Pawan Kalyan attended an oath-taking ceremony in Delhi.

CM Naidu Urges Central Govt for Support on Chilli Price Drop

- CM discusses chilli price drop with Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan.
- Seeks central support for farmers and intervention in pricing.

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu assured chilli farmers that the state government is actively addressing the sharp decline in chilli prices. Speaking at a media conference in Delhi, CM Chandrababu revealed that he had discussed the issue with Union Minister for Agriculture Shivraj Singh Chouhan and requested central intervention to stabilize prices.


CM Chandrababu attributed the fall in chilli prices to declining international demand and stated that this year's drop was unprecedented. With 12 lakh metric tons of chilli requiring procurement, 4 lakh metric tons have already entered the market. He urged the Centre to support farmers through market intervention measures and emphasized the need for pricing based on cultivation costs.

The Chief Minister noted that he had written to the Centre three times regarding the issue and state officials had engaged with the central government for solutions. He assured farmers that he would meet traders and market representatives on Saturday to assess price fluctuations and work towards a resolution.

CM Chandrababu also met Jal Shakti Minister CR Patil to review the Polavaram project, Jal Jeevan Mission, and river interlinking. He reiterated that Polavaram is on track for completion by 2027 and sought central assistance to transport its waters to Banakacharla.

Under the Jal Jeevan Mission, the Centre had sanctioned ₹27,000 crore for Andhra Pradesh, but CM Chandrababu criticized the previous government for underutilizing the funds. He highlighted that an additional ₹54,000 crore would be required to ensure tap water supply across the state and vowed to seek further central support.

CM Chandrababu emphasized that Andhra Pradesh must utilize the water flowing into the sea and said the NDA government is committed to ensuring optimal water usage for the state's development.



Pulivendula DSP Issues Notices to Krishna Reddy for Filing False Complaint **Against Viveka's Daughter**

The Pulivendula DSP has issued notices to Krishna Reddy, the former PA of late YS Vivekananda Reddy, for filing a false complaint against Viveka's daughter Sunitha and CBI SP Ramsingh.

In 2022, Krishna Reddy lodged a private complaint in Pulivendula court, claiming that CBI SP Ramsingh assaulted him to force him to name YCP leaders in the YS Vivekananda Reddy murder case. He also alleged that Sunitha and her husband Rajasekhara Reddy had threatened him. Acting on the court's directive, a case was registered against the three.

However, following an investigation by Pulivendula police, it was confirmed that Krishna Reddy's complaint was false. The CBI dismissed the allegations, stating that there was no evidence that Sunitha or Rajasekhara Reddy had exerted pressure on the investigation. DSP Murali Nayak submitted the final report in Pulivendula court, confirming that the complaint lacked merit. The magistrate is now set to review the police

Meanwhile, DSP Murali Nayak issued notices to Krishna Reddy, citing the findings of the investigation.

The Ministry of Power, Government of India, through the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), has launched the Assistance for Development of Energy Efficient Technologies in Industrial Establishments (ADEETIE) scheme to promote energy efficiency in Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs).

The scheme, announced at the BEE-Indo-German Energy Partnership National Summit in Vijayawada, aims to support MSMEs through investment-grade energy audits, technology implementation assistance, and financial incentives such as interest subvention on loans. This initiative will reduce financial stress and enable MSMEs to adopt advanced energy-efficient technologies.

Key Features of ADEETIE:

Financial Incentives: 5% interest subvention for Micro & Small enterprises, 3% for Medium enterprises.

Sector Focus: Foundry, Pharmaceuticals, Textiles, Paper, Fisheries, and other energy-intensive industries.

Dedicated Support: From initial audits to technology implementation.

BEE Secretary Milind Deora highlighted that ADEETIE is a major step towards sustainability, helping MSMEs compete globally while contributing to India's climate goals. The scheme will be implemented in phases, starting with Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, and Kerala.

The police believe these assets were funded through illegal financial transactions involving Vamsi, his aide Ranga, and the air hostess.

Additionally, the police identified another woman from Hanuman Junction who allegedly operates a boutique near the bus stand. Authorities are also investigating two women residing in a prominent Vijayawada apartment who allegedly use the space for illegal businesses and have lured young women into these activities.

The investigation has widened to include a massive 175-acre land scam in Mallavalli, where Vamsi, his younger brother, and a politician from Ampapuram are accused of involvement. Evidence also points to Vamsi's acquisition of 300 acres of land in Odisha, raising further concerns about illicit dealings.

Central to the probe is Erramsetty Ramanjaneyulu alias Potti Ramu, a close associate of Vamsi. Police allege that Ramu has been involved in illegal mining, prostitution, and drug trafficking since aligning with Vamsi in 2014. Reports suggest he trapped young men into the marijuana trade and manipulated girls for personal and financial gain.

Authorities are intensifying efforts to locate Vamsi's phone, which they believe holds critical evidence to fully expose the illegal transactions between Vamsi, Ranga, and other associates. The investigation continues to unravel the depth of the network, with further disclosures expected in the coming days.

AP Fibernet in Crisis: Chairman...

AP Fibernet Chairman GV Reddy has raised serious concerns regarding the ongoing troubles within the AP Fibernet network, highlighting severe operational and financial challenges. Speaking at a press conference, he revealed that despite managing a vast 78,000 km optical cable network, Fibernet has been facing daily disruptions that have not been addressed.

Reddy criticized the inaction of Dinesh Kumar IAS, who took charge in August but has not focused on Fibernet's issues even for a single day. He expressed suspicion over possible collusion between previous officials, stating that Fibernet has not received a single rupee since the new government came to power. Additionally, the service has not provided a single new connection under the current administration.

The Chairman also announced that three key officials Chief Technology Officer Satyarama Bharadwaj, Business Head Suresh, and Procurement Officer Shashank Haider Khan should be relieved from their duties, as their services are no longer required. He questioned why previously removed officials had not been formally terminated and criticized the delay in implementing committee decisions.

Discontent NDA alliance leaders and activists in the Mummidivaram constituency appears to be simmering beneath the surface. Despite the landslide victory of alliance candidate Datla Buchibabu, who secured a majority of over 40,000 votes, a growing divide between Telugu Desam Party (TDP) and Jana Sena Party (JSP) leaddent.

TDP leaders assert that their party played a crucial role in the victory, downplaying the contribution of Jana Sena. This claim has led to friction between the two allies, with Jana Sena leaders openly criticizing TDP representatives over the allocation of development works, sand ramp permits, liquor trade, and nominated positions. However, TDP leaders counter that several key Jana ers is becoming evi- Sena figures have al-

ready been granted sand ramps and other privileges.

Adding to the tensions, some Jana Sena activists have taken to social media, demanding that the post of Mummidivaram Marketing Committee Chairman be allocated to a woman from their party. Meanwhile, neutral voices within the alliance warn that unilateral decisions within the constituency could harm both parties in the long run, potentially strengthening the region.

Botsa dismissed the government's justification that security was removed due to the Election Code. He questioned why the same code was not applied to the Sangeetha Vibhavari event in Vijayawada, implying that security decisions were being made selectively to target Ja-

Botsa warned that if anything happened to Jagan, top officials, including the IG and SP, would be held responsible. He accused the government of deliberately creating an embarrassing situation for Jagan while he was addressing farmers' concerns about falling chili prices.

Botsa also criticized the coalition government for neglecting farmers, alleging that under YSRCP, support was provided through RBKs from seed to sale, but now middlemen were exploiting them. He blamed the current administration for weakening farmer support systems and failing to regulate fertilizer and seed prices.

YSRCP leaders are demanding that Jagan's security be restored immediately, holding the government accountable for its actions.

Referring to YSRCP's dramatic seat reduction from 151 to 11 in the elections, Sharmila stated that the public had punished the party for its inaction. "People saw through your empty rule and ensured you couldn't return to power," she asserted.

Sharmila concluded by pointing out that Jagan's governance failures had left his party without even an opposition status, marking a sharp downfall for YSRCP.

Jagan is the Brand Ambassador of Lies, Says Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu

Irrigation Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu criticized former Chief Minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy, accusing him of failing to complete the Veligonda project, which is crucial for the backward regions of Andhra Pradesh. Speaking to the media, he stated that Jagan has become the brand ambassador for lies, as his government had claimed credit for a project that was never completed.

Minister Nimmala reminded that the foundation stone for the Veligonda project was laid in 1996. By 2014, nearly 38% of the work was completed. However, instead of completing the remaining work during his tenure from 2019 to 2024, Jagan allegedly misled the people by falsely claiming its completion.

The Minister further remarked that Jagan repeat-



edly promised to finish the project but ultimately failed to do so. He ridiculed Jagan for inaugurating an incomplete project and misleading the public. "Jagan, who once toured the state in helicopters while in power, is now traveling on the very roads built by our government after losing power," Nimmala

Assuring the public, the Minister stated that the Chandrababu-led government is committed to completing the Veligonda project. He emphasized that with Rs. 4,000 crore allocated for the project, it will be completed within two years through dedicated efforts.

German Pegasus Representatives **Visit Eluru to Study Natural Farming**



TPN Correspondent Eluru, Feb 21

A delegation from Germany's Pegasus Capital visited Eluru district as part of their statewide tour to study and strengthen natural farming practices. The visit was led by T. Vijay Kumar, Executive Vice Chairman of Rythu Sadhikaran Sanstha, and included inspections of farms across Ungutur Mandal's A. Gokavaram, Bhimadolu Mandal's Vadlapatla, and Kodurupadu villages.

The team began their field study at the "Surabhi" Goshala in A. Gokavaram, where they directly observed the nine universal principles of natural farming. They examined key practices such as seed pellet preparation, solid bio-liquid application, and agnastra techniques used in chemical-free agriculture.

In ATM (Any Time Money) model rice fields, an experiment was conducted under the guidance of Kaithu T. Mallesh, assessing water utilization and productivity differences across farming methods. The delegation also studied an A-grade natural

farming model developed by APCNF Mentor Intern K. Kalyan Kumar, comparing it to a nearby chemically farmed field owned by N. Rambabu to observe the differences in crop health and sustainability.

Later, they visited U. Ramachandra Rao's coconut plantation, where banana, yam, and vegetable intercrops were being cultivated under natural farming techniques. Traffic Discipline: A Reflection of City's Order

District Collector Dr. G. Lakshmi Sha and Police Commissioner SV Rajasekhara Babu emphasized the need for a disciplined traffic system in Vijayawada, describing it as a symbol of city order. The officials chaired the Road Safety Committee (DRSC) meeting at Sri Pingali Venkayya Conference Hall in the Collectorate on Thursday, where strategies to enhance road safety were discussed.

The meeting covered: Current accident statistics - A total of 1,343 road accidents occurred in 2024, resulting in 431 deaths, with 212 on national highways, 79 on state highways, and 140 on other roads.

Action at black spots - Authorities identified 139 accident-prone areas across NH-16, NH-30, NH-65, SH-192, SH-236, SH-32, and other roads, with directives issued for immediate safety measures.

Implementation of technology - The AS-Tram (Actionable Intelligence for Sustainable Traffic Management) app was discussed for improving real-time traffic monitoring.

Infrastructure improvements - Installa-

tion of speed breakers, signboards, warning boards, and speed limit indicators, along with proposals for footover bridges and underpasses.

Police Commissioner SV Rajasekhara Babu stated that real-time traffic data is being analyzed to implement effective solutions. He noted that 84% of two-wheeler riders at Benz Circle were wearing helmets, reflecting a positive shift in traffic discipline.

Key measures undertaken include: Drone-based traffic monitoring to study congestion and road usage patterns.

Pedestrian safety initiatives, ensuring proper road crossings and minimizing jaywalking.

Signage improvements for better navigation and accident prevention.

Space utilization behind roads to avoid encroachments and improve vehicle movement.

Systematic parking solutions to streamline urban mobility.

The meeting concluded with a commitment to conduct monthly road safety committee meetings to assess progress and address new challenges.

State Agricultural **University Urged to Boost Millet** Cultivation

Widening of ADB Road Begins Amid Protests in Jaggampeta

The long-awaited widening of the Peddapuram to Rajanagaram ADB road has commenced, marking a significant step towards addressing the road's poor condition. For years, motorists have faced difficulties due to potholes and congestion, prompting the authorities to clear encroachments for the expansion project.

As part of this effort, officials in Gandepalli mandal began removing houses encroaching on the ADB road junction in Rameshwarampet. The operation was overseen by Peddapuram RDO Sri Ramani, local Tahsildar Srinivas, VROs, and revenue staff. To maintain order, Peddapuram DSP Srihari Raju, Jaggampet CI Vair K Srinivas, Gandepalli SI Shiva Nagababu, and other police officials deployed 70 personnel to ensure a smooth execution of the eviction process.

However, residents losing their homes expressed their grievances, alleging unfair treatment. Some villagers claimed they had approached Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan for intervention but received no relief. They accused



officials of acting arbitrarily and demolishing homes without considering their plight.

A major point of contention is the compensation amount. The affected residents claim that the same compensation of ₹8 lakh is being offered regardless of whether they lost 64 yards or 130 yards of land. The local Tahsildar responded by stating that the compensation had been deposited in the victims' accounts long ago and that multiple notices had been served, urging them to vacate. Authorities further clarified that residents were informed via a public announcement on Wednesday, but since they did not vacate voluntarily, police intervention was required.

R&B department engineers and officials have since moved forward with the widening process, despite the opposition from the affected families. The situation remains tense as the displaced villagers continue to protest the demolition and demand a fair resolution.

CPM Slams MLA for Ignoring Elite Land Encroachments

Rekha Gupta: BJP's Chief Minister **Choice Reflects a Decade-Long Strategy**



By appointing Rekha Gupta, a first-

time MLA, as the Chief Minister of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, the BJP leadership has continued a well-established pattern that has been fine-tuned over the last decade by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah. The BJP has consistently chosen relatively younger leaders, in their 40s or 50s, who are committed to the party's ideology, have proven organizational capabilities, and are seen as capable of managing the state's affairs for the long term.

Rekha Gupta, known for her approachable and friendly demeanor, may not have been as widely recognized as some of her colleagues in the party, but her rise to leadership speaks volumes about her dedication and political acumen. She does not exhibit the typical aura that one might expect from a high-profile politician, which sets her apart. However, her extensive background in party work and leadership has earned her respect within the BJP.

Her political journey began in student politics, where she first gained prominence as the General Secretary of the Delhi University Students' Union (DUSU) in 1995, a position she won as a nominee of the Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP), the student wing of the RSS. Despite facing

setbacks, including a loss in the 2015 assembly elections and the Mayor's election to AAP, Rekha Gupta did not back down. She remained persistent and continued her work in various capacities, including as the Chairperson of different municipal committees, Vice President of the BJP's National Mahila Morcha, and General Secretary of the party's Delhi unit. In the 2025 assembly election, she triumphed with a significant margin of nearly 30,000 votes, which is remarkable by Delhi's standards.

Rekha Gupta has been widely praised as an excellent choice to lead Delhi, a rare consensus in today's polarized political climate. With no baggage from the past and a spotless track record, she represents a refreshing change. Her identity as a woman and her roots in the Vaishya community, two key social support bases for the BJP, are additional advantages.

In terms of leadership style, Gupta brings a contrast to the aggressive and confrontational politics of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), particularly the leadership of Arvind Kejriwal and his close associate Atishi. Her style is one of poise and conciliation, signaling a potential shift toward a more cooperative approach. For voters seeking change, Rekha Gupta embodies this new direction.

Gupta has also assembled a promising cabinet, including key leaders such as Pravesh Sahib Singh Verma, Ashish Sood, Majinder Singh Sirsa, Kapil Mishra, Ravindra Indraj Singh,

and Pankaj Kumar Singh. These individuals represent different regions of Delhi and various social segments, ensuring broad representation within the government.

The broader goals and expectations for the new BJP government in Delhi were outlined by PM Modi during his address to party workers at the national headquarters following the election results. With the BJP now in power both in Delhi and at the Centre, there is hope that the tensions between the Delhi Lieutenant Governor and the Chief Minister, which had become a daily feature under AAP's rule, will finally subside. The new government is expected to work in harmony with the Centre to deliver effective governance.

Even before Gupta's swearing-in, efforts to clean the Yamuna River had already begun, with images of machines being used to clean the water going viral. Additionally, repair work on damaged roads in certain areas has already started.

In line with her promises, Gupta's first major announcement as Chief Minister was to transfer ₹2,500 as monthly assistance to eligible women's bank accounts by March 8, International Women's Day.

While Gupta faces significant challenges, the resources and support from the Modi government offer her a unique opportunity to transform Delhi into a model city known for its hygiene, infrastructure, and governance.



Congress Reshuffle: Rahul Chooses His Inner Circle, But Can They Deliver?



The Congress party has recently carried out a long-awaited reshuffle in its secretariat, but it appears to be a half-hearted effort, especially coming after three consecutive state poll defeats. The reshuffle includes the appointment of two new general secretaries and a handful of changes to the party's state in-charges. The central question is whether this new team can strengthen Rahul Gandhi, who, after reaching a high point last year with 99 seats in the Lok Sabha, is now facing a challenging period. Rahul's Inner Circle

It is clear that Rahul Gandhi has carefully chosen his inner circle, promoting trusted allies who have been working behind the scenes. One common criticism of Gandhi has been that he fails to bring the party along with him and often operates independently. However, with his close associates now in prominent positions, that perception could

The new appointments are strategic,

with many of them being leaders from marginalized or minority communities. Bhupesh Baghel, former Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh, has been appointed as general secretary for Punjab, while Syed Naseer Hussain will handle Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh. Other key appointments include Ajay Kumar Lallu for Odisha, B.K. Hariprasad for Haryana, and Saptagiri Sankar Ulaka for Manipur, Sikkim, Tripura, and Nagaland. Former MP Meenakshi Natrajan will handle Telangana, and K. Raju will take over Jharkhand.

Can This Reshuffle Change Congress's Fate?

The reshuffle raises the question: Can this team change the Congress's fortunes? That remains uncertain. Although Mallikarjun Kharge holds the position of Congress President, K.C. Venugopal, the General Secretary for Organization, continues to be the true power broker behind the scenes, largely due to his strong ties to the Gandhi family. Priyanka Gandhi Vadra also holds a significant role, though her exact function in the party remains ambiguous.

One notable aspect of the reshuffle is that the "old guard" has been largely sidelined, with many experienced leaders passed over in favor of younger figures. This could be seen as Rahul Gandhi's attempt to reassert control and break away from the legacy of senior leaders whose authority he may find limiting.

Focus on Bihar and Punjab

Two key regions stand out in the reshuffle: Punjab and Bihar. Baghel's appointment to Punjab is curious, given his recent track record of failure in Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra. With BJP, Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD), and AAP all vying for influence in Punjab, it remains to be seen if Baghel's leadership will help Con-

gress regain ground. In Bihar, the Congress continues to play second fiddle to the Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD). The appointment of Krishna Allavaru, a relatively low-profile leader, as the in-charge for Bihar, suggests that the Congress is content with its junior status within the alliance. This aligns with Rahul Gandhi's recent efforts to strengthen ties with Lalu Prasad Yadav and his son, Tejashwi, further signaling Congress's dependence on regional parties in key states like Bihar and Puducherry.

A Deeper Issue: Lack of

Soul-Searching

The Congress party's primary issue is that it has not engaged in any serious soul-searching since its near-collapse in the 2014 general elections. The formation of the IN-DIA bloc—an alliance of opposition parties—is essentially an admission that Congress cannot defeat the BJP alone.



The reshuffle, which includes two new general secretaries and nine new in-charges, is unlikely to energize party workers or address the party's deep-rooted challenges. Although the new appointees are trusted by Rahul Gandhi, their effectiveness remains to be seen, especially as the future of the INDIA bloc is uncertain. Furthermore, Congress continues to face an existential crisis in states like Tamil Nadu and

West Bengal, where it struggles to maintain relevance.

In conclusion, the success of this reshuffle hinges more on Rahul Gandhi's leadership than on the new team itself. It remains to be seen if this team can deliver the much-needed revitalization for Congress, or if it will simply be another chapter in the party's ongoing struggle.

Calcutta High Court Chief Justice Recuses Himself from R.G. Kar Rape and Murder PIL Case TPN Correspondent | J&K

Calcutta High Court Chief Justice T.S. Sivagnanam recused himself on Thursday from hearing a public interest litigation (PIL) filed in connection with the rape and murder of a junior doctor at the R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital in August last year. The PIL had been filed against former Kolkata Police Commissioner Vineet Kumar Goyal, alleging that he revealed the victim's identity while interacting with the media, which led to nationwide protests.

As the case came before the division bench of Chief Justice Sivagnanam and Justice Chaitali Chatterjee, the Chief Justice expressed his desire to step down from the case for personal reasons. He directed the court authorities to remove the matter from the cause list, and it will now be referred to another division bench for hearing.

The PIL, filed in November last year during the height of protests following the tragic incident, sought the registration of an FIR against Goyal. The division bench had earlier directed the Union Department of Personnel & Training (DOPT) to be included as a party in the case, as it is the cadre-control authority for all Indian Police Service (IPS) officers like Goyal. The court sought an affidavit from DOPT explaining what action could be taken against any all-India service officer for breaching the law.

The Union government had informed the Calcutta High Court that there were no restrictions preventing the West Bengal government from taking action against Goyal. It also mentioned that the petitioner could make a fresh appeal if the state government failed to act.

Goyal, who is currently the Additional Director General of the West Bengal Police's Special Task Force (STF), faced widespread criticism for his handling of the initial investigation. Junior doctors had demanded his removal, and the Chief Minister eventually replaced him with Manoj Kumar Verma. The investigation was later transferred to the CBI.

Both the Supreme Court and the Calcutta High Court had previously made strong observations about the revelation of the victim's identity. It remains to be seen which division bench will now hear the case.



Maharashtra **Minister Manikrao Kokate Gets 2-Year Jail In Cheating Case**

Maharashtra Agriculture Minister and NCP leader Manikrao Kokate was sentenced to two years in prison by a Nashik court on Thursday in connection with a 1995 case. The case involved charges of submitting fake documents to obtain flats under a government quota meant for the Low Income Group (LIG).

Following the conviction, Kokate told reporters that the court had granted him bail, and he planned to challenge the judgment by filing an appeal in the High Court.

The court also convicted Kokate's brother, Sunil Kokate, in the same case, imposing a fine of Rs 50,000 each on both brothers. However, two other individuals involved in the case were acquitted by the court. The case was originally filed in 1995 based on a complaint by former minister, the late T. S. Dighole, who had political differences with Kokate.

According to the prosecution, the Kokate brothers had been allotted two flats in the Yeolakar Mala area of Nashik under the Chief Minister's 10% discretionary quota, which was meant for LIG citizens. The brothers allegedly misrepresented their eligibility by falsely claiming to belong to the LIG category and denying ownership of any property in the city.

The case was brought to light when Dighole lodged a complaint, prompting a police investigation. The Kokate brothers were charged with cheating, forgery, and other offenses under the Indian Penal Code.

The ruling has sparked political reactions, with the rival NCP (SP) calling for Kokate's resignation following the verdict. Kokate's situation could also lead to his disqualification as an MLA if he does not receive relief from the High Court.

This case adds to the challenges facing the NCP, as Kokate is the second minister in the Ajit Pawar-led NCP faction of the BJP-led state government to face legal troubles. Cabinet Minister Dhananjay Munde is currently under scrutiny following his aide's arrest in an extortion case linked to a village sarpanch's murder in Beed district in December 2024.

Week After President's Rule, Manipur **Governor's 7-Day Arms Ultimatum**

Manipur Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla has called on people from all communities in the state to surrender any looted or illegally held weapons and ammunition within the next seven days. In a statement issued today, Governor Bhalla emphasized that no punitive action would be taken against those who comply with this directive before the deadline. However, he warned that strict legal measures would follow for those who fail to return illegal weapons after the seven-day period.

This announcement comes as Manipur continues to grapple with the aftermath of violent ethnic clashes between the Meitei community and the Kuki tribes that have disrupted the region for nearly two years. These tensions, compounded by the state's open border with Myanmar, have led to significant unrest, forcing the government to take drastic measures. Currently, Manipur is under The appeal for the voluntary surrender of weapons Minister N Biren Singh and his council of ministers on February 9. The state assembly is now in suspended animation, with elected members no longer holding power.

Governor Bhalla's call for disarmament is part of an effort to restore peace and normalcy in a region that has endured immense hardship over the past



20 months. The violence, which has deeply affected both the valley and hill areas of the state, has disrupted daily life and led to the loss of numerous lives. In his statement, the Governor urged all communities, whether from the valley or the hills, to actively participate in ceasing hostilities and working towards maintaining peace and order.

President's rule, following the resignation of Chief aims to defuse ongoing tensions and create a more secure environment for the people of Manipur. While the Governor expressed understanding for the suffering endured by the people, he stressed the importance of collective responsibility in ensuring the restoration of harmony. The state's leadership, now under President's rule, is hoping this initiative will help bring an end to the violence and allow residents to return to their normal lives.

UGC draft regulations 2025 aimed at sidelining states from higher education: Kerala CM

Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan strongly criticized the draft University Grants Commission (UGC) regulations of 2025 on Thursday, stating that they significantly diminish and even sideline the role of state governments in higher education. Speaking at a National Convention on the draft UGC regulations, attended by ministers from neighboring states like Telangana, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu, Vijayan expressed concerns about the implications for state autonomy.

Vijayan pointed out that under the draft regulations, the appointment of Vice Chancellors (VCs) would be under the control of Chancellors, who are typically Governors appointed by the central government. He warned that this could lead to politically motivated selections that would harm the quality of higher edu-

cation. The Kerala CM highlighted what he called "gubernatorial excesses" experienced in opposition-ruled states, including Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and Punjab, where Governors have interfered in university affairs.

He also referenced the state's previous experience with former Kerala Governor Arif Mohammed Khan, who had withheld assent to bills related to university administration, forcing the state government to approach the Supreme Court. Vijayan further criticized the draft regulations for introducing "new and arbitrary criteria" for the promotion of academic staff, describing these changes as an infringement on the autonomy of states.



Maharashtra Dy CM Eknath Shinde

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde received a death threat via email on Thursday, February 20, which warned of an explosion targeting the Shiv Sena leader's car. Along with Shinde, the Goregaon and JJ Marg police stations and the Mantralaya (state secretariat) also received similar threatening messages.

Mumbai Police, along with the Crime Branch, have launched a detailed investigation to trace the sender's IP address and identify those responsible for the threat. In response to the incident, security around Shinde has been bolstered to ensure his safety.

Gupta as Delhi's Chief Minister. Speaking on the occasion, he expressed his joy, stating, "It is a matter of joy that our 'Ladli Behna' (beloved sister) will take the oath in Delhi... We thank PM Modi for this." This is not the first time that Shinde has faced a death threat. The accused student, identified as Shubham Warkad, was arrested by the Mumbai Crime Branch from Pune on February 16, 2024. He had posted the threats on the social media platform X, prompting immediate police intervention.

Authorities had charged Warkad under sections 506(2) and 505(1)(B) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). The police investigation into the recent death threat continues, with heightened vigilance around the Deputy CM's security.



Indian Man Arrested For Balloon Explosion That Injured Nepal Deputy PM Bishnu Paudel

An Indian national, Kamlesh Kumar, has been arrested in Nepal in connection with an incident during the inauguration of the 'Visit Pokhara Year 2025' tourism event, where Deputy Prime Minister Bishnu Paudel sustained minor burn injuries. Police revealed that Kumar was responsible for filling hydrogen gas into balloons, which later exploded during the ceremony.

The explosion occurred on February 15, shortly after Paudel and Pokhara Metropolitan City Mayor Dhanraj Acharya released the hydrogen gas-filled balloons along with a banner. This was part of a symbolic gesture that included lighting candles through an electric switch. The balloons caught fire when the flames from the candles were too close, causing them to explode. Both Paudel and Acharya suffered burns and were airlifted to Kathmandu for medical treatment.

Following the incident, a case was filed against the 41-yearold Kumar in Kaski district court, as confirmed by Deputy Superintendent of Police Basanta Sharma. The explosion was reportedly triggered by a spark from the automatic switch that ignited the hydrogen-filled balloons.

The incident was captured on video by numerous social media users, with footage showing the balloons bursting into a large explosion and injuring those nearby. Paudel, who also serves as Nepal's finance minister, and Acharya suffered burns on their hands and faces. Paudel was discharged from Kirtipur Burn Hospital in Kathmandu on Monday after receiving treatment, while Acharya remained under medical care for a few more days.

In response to the incident, Home Minister Ramesh Lekhak quickly formed an investigation committee to look into the matter and determine the cause and responsibility for the explosion. The event, which was meant to highlight tourism in Pokhara, turned tragic due to the mishandling of hazardous materials.



Russia Holds "The Cards" In Peace Talks With Ukraine: Trump

US President Donald Trump has stated that Russia holds a significant advantage in the ongoing peace talks regarding the Russia-Ukraine war, as they control a large portion of Ukrainian territory. In comments reported by the BBC, Trump expressed his belief that Russia has the upper hand in negotiations due to their territorial gains. "I think the Russians want to see the war end, I really do. I think they have the cards a little bit, because they've taken a lot of territory. They have the cards," he said.

This statement comes in the wake of a high-level meeting between US officials, led by Secretary of State Marco Rubio, and top Russian diplomats in Saudi Arabia on February 18. Ukraine was notably absent from the talks, prompting Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky to cancel his planned visit, which had been scheduled for Wednesday.

Trump addressed the situation at a press conference at his residence in Florida, questioning Ukraine's absence from the discussions. "Today I heard, 'Oh, well, we weren't invited.' Well, you've been there for three years. You should have ended it three years ago. You should have never started it. You could have made a deal," Trump remarked.

In response to the US-Russia talks, Zelensky criticized Trump, stating that the former president was operating in a "disinformation space." He expressed his disapproval of Trump's stance, suggesting that it lacked understanding of the situation's complexity.

Meanwhile, Kremlin spokesperson Dmitry Peskov confirmed that Russia is open to continuing discussions with the US on all fronts. Peskov stated that Russia "absolutely agrees with the American administration" that negotiations are essential to achieve peace and end the conflict as soon as possible.

Germany Prepares for Critical Federal Election: A Race Between Scholz, Merz, and Weidel

- · Germany votes on February 23 to elect a new chancellor
- · Scholz, Merz, and Weidel lead a highly competitive race
- · CDU leads in polls; coalition talks expected post-election

Germany is set to hold its crucial federal election on Sunday, February 23, with voters choosing the next chancellor to shape the future of the country and its role within the European Union. The election follows the collapse of Chancellor Olaf Scholz's coalition government at the end of 2024, prompting snap polls to determine Germany's leadership. Scholz, seeking a second term, faces strong opposition from Friedrich Merz, the leader of the Christian Democratic Union (CDU), and Alice Weidel, a far-right candidate from the Alternative for Germany (AfD).

Top Contenders

Olaf Scholz:The 66-year-old incumbent from the Social Democrats (SPD) has served as chancellor since December 2021. Scholz is seeking re-election after leading efforts to modernize Germany's military, supply weapons to Ukraine, and tackle energy shortages. However, his three-party coalition suffered infighting, leading to its collapse in November 2024.

Friedrich Merz:At 69, Merz is the leader of the CDU and the front-runner in the race, according to recent polls. A conservative voice, Merz has made curbing immigration a central issue. Though he lacks direct government experience, his leadership has brought the CDU to prominence after Angela Merkel's tenure.



Robert Habeck: The 55-year-old co-leader of the Green Party, currently serving as vice chancellor and economy and climate minister, is another key contender. Habeck's tenure has been marked by his role in managing energy issues and spearheading environmental policies, though his ministry's proposals on heating systems have been divisive.

Alice Weidel: The 46-year-old economist is leading the far-right AfD in a historic bid for chancellor. Though the AfD is unlikely to form a government, Weidel's candidacy highlights the growing influence of far-right politics in Germany.

Election Outlook and Coalition Dynamics

Election results are expected to be confirmed by Sunday evening, though final outcomes may take longer due to post-election vote counting. Germany's proportional voting system often leads to coalition governments, making post-election negotiations crucial. Given the fragmentation in German politics, coalition talks could extend for months.

With no party likely to win an outright majority, the key to forming a stable government will lie in alliances between the SPD, CDU, Greens, and possibly the AfD. Recent polls show the CDU leading with 30%, followed by the AfD at 20%. Scholz's SPD has dropped to third with just 16%, highlighting the shifting political landscape in Germany.

India Responds After Illegal Migrants Deported By US Seek "Help" In Panama

India is working closely with Panamanian authorities to ensure the safety and well-being of Indian migrants who were recently deported by the United States to Panama. According to the Indian embassy in Panama, the deportees are currently safe and secure at a hotel where they are being detained. The embassy confirmed that the migrants have access to essential facilities, and a consular team has been granted access to provide assistance.

"Panamanian authorities have informed us that a group of Indians have reached Panama from the US. They are safe and secure at a hotel with all essential facilities. Embassy team has obtained consular access. We are working closely with the host Government to ensure their well-being," the embassy said in a statement on X (formerly Twitter).

This announcement follows reports that nearly 300 migrants, including individuals from India, Iran, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Afghanistan, and China, were being held in

Panama after being deported from the United States under former President Donald Trump's administration. Some deportees were seen displaying desperate messages through their hotel room windows, pleading for help and stating, "We are not safe in our country."

In response, Panama's authorities have denied claims that the migrants are being detained against their will. Panamanian Security Minister Frank Abrego stated that these deportees are receiving medical care and food as part of a migration agreement between Panama and the United States. However, they are not allowed to leave the hotel until arrangements are made for their repatriation to their countries of origin.

The United States has been using Panama as a transit point for deportees due to logistical challenges in deporting individuals directly to certain countries. Costa Rica is also expected to receive a similar flight carrying third-country deportees. The US has adopted a tough stance on undocumented migration under President Trump, with plans to deport large numbers of individuals as part of his administration's immigration policies.


Why Would One Be Afraid?: Mexican President On Donald Trump's Threats

Mexican President Claudia Sheinbaum has expressed confidence in the face of US President Donald Trump's threats of mass deportations, trade tariffs, and military intervention to combat drug cartels. Sheinbaum, speaking at a daily press conference, stated that she does not fear Trump's warnings because she has the support of the Mexican people.

When asked about Trump's recent comments, Sheinbaum confidently responded, "No. I have the support of the people. When one has certainty and conviction and knows what one's principles are, why would one be afraid?" She emphasized that Mexico's sovereignty would never be violated, and if it were, the entire country would stand together to defend it.

Sheinbaum's remarks followed Trump's



statement that Mexico is "run by drug cartels" and his accusations that Mexican authorities were allowing millions of people to enter the United States illegally. Trump also offered his "help" to curb the flow of immigration.

Sheinbaum allayed concerns over Trump's actions by noting that there is ongoing dialogue between the two governments. She stressed that while Mexico does not support

drug cartels or organized crime, it firmly defends its sovereignty and would not accept any "extraterritorial measures" resulting from the US designating drug cartels as terrorist organizations.

The tension escalated earlier this month when Trump threatened, but later postponed, a 25% tariff on Mexican imports, aimed at pressuring Mexico to take stronger action against its drug cartels. Trump had also ordered the designation of some Mexican drug cartels as foreign terrorist organizations, a move that is expected to be finalized soon.

In response to Trump's tariff threat, Mexico deployed 10,000 National Guard troops to its northern border. Meanwhile, the Mexican Defense Secretary, Ricardo Trevilla, addressed the issue of US military flights, stating they had not entered Mexican airspace, although their purpose remained unclear.



Domestic Markets Consolidate as Metals, Energy & **Auto Support Recovery Amid Global Uncertainty**

Domestic stock markets closed slightly lower on Thursday. Consolidation is underway in the benchmark and broad indices. If the respective sectoral indices rebound for a few more days, a direction will emerge for the markets. The indices fell in the morning due to mixed signals from Asian and international markets and FIIs leaving. Later, investors bought attractive shares and found support from metal, energy and auto shares, leading to a recovery. Nifty 18 and Sensex lost 203 points.

The BSE Sensex, which closed at 75,939 in the previous session, opened at 75,672 on Thursday. It touched an intraday low of 75,463. It reached an intraday high of 75,794. It finally closed at 75,735, down 203 points. The NSE Nifty, which opened at 22,821, touched a low of 22,812 and a high of 22,923. It closed at 22,913, down 19 points. The Nifty Bank fell 235 points to settle at 49,334.

In the Nifty50, 28 companies gained while 22 lost. Shares of auto, media, metal, PSU bank, realty, oil and gas sectors rose. Bank, finance, IT, and private bank shares faced selling pressure. Shriram Finance, NTPC, M&M, BEL, and Adani Ports were the top gainers. HDFC Bank, Maruti, TechM, Tata Consumer, and HCL Tech were the top losers.

Indian Auto Component **Industry Set for Moderate Growth Amid Challenges**

The Indian auto component industry is expected to see an 8-10 percent growth in revenue in the financial year 2025-26, according to a report from rating agency ICRA. This follows a more moderate growth projection for the current year, 2024-25, where revenues are forecast to rise by only 7-9 percent, down from the high growth rate of 14 percent witnessed in 2023-24.

Despite this slowdown in growth, ICRA's report indicates that operating margins for the sector are likely to remain stable, hovering between 11-12 percent in both 2024-25 and 2025-26. This stability is expected to be supported by operating leverage, which allows companies to better manage fixed costs as they scale up production, along with an increase in the content per vehicle and added value from the components produced.

However, there are significant challenges facing the industry, particularly in the form of rising ocean freight rates. The ongoing disruptions along the Red Sea route have caused a surge in shipping costs, with rates jumping 2-3 times higher in 2024 compared to the previous year. This surge in ocean freight rates could potentially impact the margins of auto component suppliers, especially those with substantial exports or imports. A further increase in these rates could lead to additional financial strain for businesses that rely heavily on global supply chains.

Looking ahead, ICRA estimates the auto component industry will incur capital expenditures (Capex) of Rs 25,000-30,000 crore in 2025-26. These investments will be directed towards capacity expansion, localisation efforts, and technological advancements, including the development of electric vehicles (EVs). At present, only 30-40 percent of the EV supply chain in India is localised, with progress made in areas such as traction motors, control units, and battery management systems. However, battery cells, which account for 35-40 percent of the vehicle cost, remain fully imported, indicating a continued dependency on global supply chains in the short term.

Overall, while the Indian auto component industry faces a moderate growth outlook and some external challenges, its focus on expanding capacity and localising supply chains—especially in the EV sector presents opportunities for long-term stability and growth.



India's Economic Outlook Remains **Strong Amid Global Uncertainty**

India's economic activity is expected to gain momentum in the second half of 2024-25, according to the latest Reserve Bank of India (RBI) monthly bulletin, which highlights the country's resilience despite global challenges. High-frequency indicators point to a recovery in various sectors, with the economy on track to maintain its position as the fastest-growing major economy in the world during 2025-26, with GDP growth estimates of 6.5% from the IMF and 6.7% from the World Bank.

The report underscores that the Union Budget for 2025-26 has struck a balanced approach, prioritizing fiscal consolidation while supporting growth through continued focus on capital expenditure (Capex). The budget also includes measures to boost household incomes and consumption. The effective capital expenditure/GDP ratio is projected to rise to 4.3% in 2025-26 from 4.1% in the previous year, reflecting the government's commitment to long-term infrastruc-



ture development.Retail inflation has moderated to a five-month low of 4.3% in January, driven by a sharp decline in vegetable prices due to the arrival of winter crops. This has helped alleviate cost pressures for consumers. Furthermore, high-frequency indicators indicate a recovery in industrial activity and overall economic momentum during the latter half of 2024-25, after a slower first half.

Sector-specific indicators reflect this recovery: tractor sales, fuel consumption, and air passenger traffic all show positive trends. Rural demand remains robust, buoyed by higher farm incomes, with FMCG sales in rural areas growing by 9.9% in Q3:2024-25, compared to 5.7% in Q2. Urban demand also saw improvement, with a 5% growth in Q3, almost do uble the growth in the previous quarter.

Investment intentions from the private sector remain stable, with substantial projects sanctioned by banks and financial institutions, totaling nearly ₹1 lakh crore in Q3:2024-25. External Commercial Borrowings and Initial Public Offerings for capital expenditure also showed an uptick.

Despite global uncertainties, including trade tensions and geopolitical risks, India's strong macroeconomic fundamentals have helped cushion the impact, according to the RBI bulletin. The report emphasizes that global trade patterns may undergo a long-term shift due to these uncertainties.

India set to become high-income country by 2047 buoyed by services sector

India is on track to emerge as a high-in- nomic potential, positioncome country by 2047, with projections indicating its GDP could reach between USD 23 trillion to USD 35 trillion. The services sector will play a significant role in this transformation, contributing around 60 percent to India's GDP by the target year, according to a report by Bain & Company and Nasscom.

Manufacturing will also make a major contribution, expected to account for approximately 32 percent of the GDP. These two sectors—services and manufacturing—are seen as key drivers of India's future economic expansion.

A crucial element in this shift will be the addition of nearly 200 million individuals to the workforce, which presents India with a unique opportunity to create high-value jobs. This demographic change could unlock substantial eco-

ing the country to harness the benefits of a growing, skilled labor force.

The report emphasizes that a sectoral technology roadmap could be instrumental in fueling this transformation. Advances in artificial intelligence (AI)-driven chip design, touchless manufacturing, and backward integration into component manufacturing are ex-

pected to make Indian industries more cost-competitive and innovative. As a result, India's technology export share could rise from the current 24 percent to 45-50 percent by 2047, while the sector's contribution to the GDP could grow from 3 percent to between 8-10 percent.



The combination of these factors—economic growth driven by services and manufacturing, a burgeoning workforce, and technological advancements—could position India as a leading global economic powerhouse by mid-century.

WhatsApp Bans Over 8 Million Accounts in a Month



WhatsApp, India's largest social media platform, has banned more than 8.4 million accounts in a single month to curb fraudulent activities and ensure user safety. The move, announced by Meta—the parent company of WhatsApp—comes amid rising concerns about scams and suspicious activities on the platform.

According to Meta's Transparency Re- measures were part of Meta's ongoing

port, this mass ban was a direct response to increasing reports from users about fraudulent behavior, prompting the company to take swift action to maintain the integrity of the platform. The banned accounts, totaling approximately 8.45 million, were identified as violating the provisions of Section 4(1)(d) and Section 3A(7) of the Information Technology Act. These

efforts to uphold safety and compliance within India's digital ecosystem.

The bans took place between August 1 and August 31, with Meta detailing the types of accounts affected. Of the total number, 1.66 million accounts were immediately blocked due to serious violations, while the remaining accounts were banned after thorough investigations revealed suspicious activities. Interestingly, over 1.6 million of these accounts were flagged and banned proactively during routine monitoring, even before receiving specific user complaints. These accounts were found to be engaged in misuse, underlining the importance of early detection in maintaining a safe environment for WhatsApp users.

Meta's aggressive approach reflects its commitment to addressing concerns over fraud on its platforms and improving monitoring systems. The company's actions also serve as a reminder of the increasing responsibility social media platforms have in curbing online scams and providing users with a secure digital experience.

Uber Ditches Commissions for Auto-Rickshaw Drivers Introduces Subscription Model

Uber has announced a major change for auto-rickshaw drivers in India, eliminating its commission fees and replacing them with a subscription model. In a blog post on Tuesday, February 18, the ride-hailing giant revealed that drivers will now keep 100% of the fares earned through the platform.

Previously, Uber charged a commission on each fare, which resulted in drivers receiving only a portion of the total fare. However, with this new model, drivers will no longer face deductions from Uber. Instead, the company will charge a subscription fee for using the platform, allowing drivers to retain the full fare amount paid by passengers.

The shift to a subscription-based structure is designed to offer more earnings stability for auto-rickshaw drivers, particularly during times of fluctuating demand. Uber's move comes as part of its broader efforts to improve relationships with drivers and enhance the overall driver experience.


